What to watch for on Meadowlands Pace night

The BIGGEST STORYLINES for one of the biggest nights of the year.

As is the case every year, the most anticipated evening card of the year at The Meadowlands is stacked from top to bottom, including the sport's current top three rated horses in action. Highlighted by the \$600,000 Meadowlands Pace, nine of the 14 races on the card boast six-figure purses. Here are a few things to look out for across the night. In, mostly, race order:

WHAT SHAPE WILL THE HAMBLETONIAN TAKE?

I know the focus of the night is on the pacers, but eliminations for the Hambletonian are just two weeks away and Saturday will give us a good read on how that race will take form. Most of the buzz this year to date has come from the filly, Joviality. That's been rightly so, but Saturday brings out some of the bigger guns that she hasn't seen, yet.

Starting with Joviality, she makes her return to the Meadowlands for the first time since closing out last year with wins in the Breeders Crown and Goldsmith Maid. With respect due to the Yonkers Trot, it's debatable that the caliber of fillies racing Saturday in the Del Miller Memorial are just as talented, if it more, than the male rivals Joviality beat at Yonkers. In her division of the Delvin Miller (race 3), Joviality faces a field that includes top 2-year-olds from last year Lilbitalexis, Misswalner Fashion, Venerable and Selfie Queen who may have turned into



a bit of a project as Jimmy Takter makes his return appearance this year at The Meadowlands in the bike. The other Del Miller division in race 2 has talent, too. That race features Raised By Lindy who just missed to Joviality in last year's Breeders Crown, New Jersey Sires Stakes champion Fashion Schooner, and Manon, who is unbeaten in 2022. The point being, Joviality has passed all the early season tests so far but here's where the competition gets deeper and that's just on the filly's side alone.

As of right now, the road to the Hambletonian might actually go through Rebuff. The Breeders Crown champion makes his second start of the year in race 4, a division of the Stanley Dancer and he was incredible last out in his first start back. He tracked cover of the heavily-backed Fast As The Wind and exploded late with a :26.2 final quarter and a final time of 1:51.3 right out of the gate. In addition to those two horses who rematch on Saturday, there's loads of other Hambletonian hopefuls in this Dancer division as well as the one in race 6. There could be some surprises in store.

WILL TREACHEROUS DRAGON REMAIN UNBEATEN ON THE YEAR?

Treacherous Dragon makes her second start since moving barns from Pelling to Takter and we'll see if she can extend her winning streak this year to a perfect seven in the Mistletoe Shalee going as race 7. Unraced since June 26, she qualified nicely enough last week, and I think will get tested from the two fillies coming out of the Nadia Lobell. Boudoir Hanover wasn't good enough for Treacherous Dragon up at Woodbine, but her and Trick Of The Light went toe to toe in a fast 1:48.3 mile two weeks ago at Hoosier; she might be good enough now. Going for the sharp barns of Tony Alagna and Brian Brown, respectively, you have to figure they'll both come ready. Todd McCarthy was listed on both those horses as well on the overnights; assuming he'll go to Boudoir Hanover with a real chance to win.

IS TEST OF FAITH UNBEATABLE?

I was going to bypass this race entirely on the basis of Test Of Faith drawing the rail and not having anything new to add, but received a note from a friend with a deeper critical thinking ability than myself and thought it couldn't hurt to pass along. He says, "Racine Bell being in that mare's race (Dorothy Haughton Memorial, race 9) changes that dynamic. I see her close up and pouncing."

CAN BULLDOG HANOVER GO SUB 1:46?

With his win last week in the Graduate, Bulldog Hanover became the sport's latest millionaire and remains in rarified form. Fresh off his record-tying 1:46 mile two weeks ago, he came right back last Saturday to almost repeat the trick, this time just a tick of a second slower in 1:46.1. It's almost incomprehensible to even type but a 1:45 and change mile with this supporting caliber of competition seems possible. At this time, the weather forecast calls for similar warm conditions, looking forward to seeing what display the Bulldog can put once again in the \$500,000 William Haughton as race 10. Not to be overlooked, Rockyroad Hanover shouldn't be disregarded entirely as an upset threat. His post stinks once again, but he definitely had solid late momentum last week and if not for being slightly overshadowed by Bulldog Hanover, those back-to-back 1:46.2 miles would be getting more attention.

WILL RATTLE MY CAGE FACE A CHALLENGE?

You won't often see an easier win for \$250,000 than what Rattle My Cage did last week in the Graduate. Unchallenged and untested throughout, he strolled through leisurely fractions en route to his fourth straight win. Maybe that \$250,000 race was just a prep for the "real" race, this \$400,000 Hambletonian Maturity; who knows? That race was over once Cuatro De Julio seeming inexplicably changed tactics and got away 10th, and I'd be floored if he doesn't revert back to his speed favoring tactics. He once again has a bad post and starts directly to the outside of Rattle My Cage, but this race will be contested

at an extra eighth of a mile so those two will have plenty of straightaway to sort things out prior to the first turn. Bella Bellini gives the males a shot after continuing to overwhelm female rivals in her division, and she'll start from the post 11 second tier. Ambassador Hanover split foes with late trot last week and that's a couple straight races he's closed as a longshot.

WHO WILL WIN THE MEADOWLANDS PACE?

There's a great script already written if Beach Glass were to go on and capture the Meadowlands Pace. From the final crop of Somebeachsomewhere for the same small ownership group from Nova Scotia along with the same trainer that campaigned that super horse, it would obviously be quite something if Beach Glass were to win the race that denied his sire in one of the all-time great races 14 years ago. I wrote last week in this column that I was waiting for a "wow" type of mile from Beach Glass and he certainly delivered with a massive mile; 1:48.1 after being used as part of an early pace battle to clear to the lead past a :53.2 half. He should have earned a lot of respect with that mile and because of that Gingras may be more easily able to dictate terms now in the final; not invincible but he is a deserving favorite.

Night Hawk lands his best post in a while and I'd have to think that Miller will be more aggressive with him in this race than he was in the North America Cup final. Once he caught a gear through the stretch last week it surely looked that he was going to get up, though maybe he leveled off just a touch as Market Based was able to show some determination and fend him off late after getting the pocket trip. He kind of reminded me of longshot Hellabalou who left from the same post 7 and got a 2-hole ride, just as Market Based did. Captain Cowboy was one I spoke highly of last week and he did well for himself at 10-1 in his elimination to rally up late for second. If the race sets up for a closer he could be in a prime position to take advantage of it; dangerous connections right now. I still think both Caviart Camden and Early Action – top horses from last year – need a little more. I Did It Myway went a 1:48.1 mile two back and then was used early in his elimination; he does have speed if McCarthy wants to take a shot. Fourever Boy would need a pace meltdown but might take some play off his elimination rally. Mad Max Hanover was actually Tetrick's pick a few races ago over I Did It Myway and he's still here, maybe there's something there. I wouldn't have seen it with Captainryanmichael, even with a decent post.



Somebeachsomewhere could extend his legacy on Meadowlands Pace Night

Six of the 10 finalists are either a son or grandson of the late legend.

We are staring at an unprecedented Meadowlands Pace finish in 2022. There is a strong likelihood that the winner will either be a son or grandson of Somebeachsomewhere, the stallion that died away four-and-a-half years ago.

Three finalists are by SBSW's son Captaintreacherous (Captain Cowboy, I Did It My Way and Captainryanmichael), two are by SBSW's son Huntsville (Caviart Camden and Early Action) and one (Beach Glass) is from the Somebeachsomewhere's final crop.

No horse has won the Meadowlands Pace after their sire has died.

Also, no Pace winner has ever been from a sire's last crop. SBSW would also be the first to win the Pace with progeny from his first crop (Captaintreacheous -2013) and last.

Here's a look at some major accomplishments that happened long after a horse's sire had died:

- 1. Sportswriter won the 2009 Metro and 2010 NA Cup. His sire, Artsplace, died in 2006.
- 2. Keystone Velocity was the 2017 Older Male Pacer of the year a decade after sire Western Hanover died in 2007.
- 3. Arch Madness banked \$4.3 million career and set the alltime record for Breeders Crown final appearances. His sire, Balanced Image, died three years before Arch Madness first competed.
- 4. Chapter Seven was the 2012 Horse of the Year four years after sire Windsongs Legacy died.

5. Cam Fella's last race was in the same 24-hour window when his sire Most Happy Fella died. At that exact moment, Most Happy Fella had \$39 million in siring credits. But, he was far from done. He wound up his siring career at \$93 million plus. Amazingly, Armbro Feather won the 1989 mares open pace Breeders Crown six years after dad died. (P.S. — Cam Fella himself sired his richest ever performer from his last crop — \$3.7 million earner Eternal Camnation)

OLD TIMERS NIGHT

The last four Meadowlands Pace finals have seen an oddity — the average age of the winning sire has been 19.5 years:

2018 - Courtly Choice (sired by Art Major, 19)


2019 - Best In Show (Bettors Delight, 21)

2020 - Tall Dark Stranger (Bettors Delight, 22)

2021 - Lawless Shadow (Shadow Play, 16)

GINGRAS BACK WITH THE PACE FAVORITE

Yannick Gingras is driving the 2022 Meadowlands Pace favorite, Beach Glass, two years ago he won with Tall Dark Stranger as the public choice and 18 years ago he debuted with the 9-5 favorite Timesareachanging (second for Brett Pelling). Gingras will try to join Mike Lachance, John Campbell and Ron Pierce as the fourth driver to win a Meadowlands Pace before and after going into the Hall Of Fame.

DIANE LEWIS BACK, TOO

Caretaker (to the stars) Diane Lewis is back in the Meadowlands Pace with Early Action. In 2021, she had Perfect Sting.

OH, BROTHERS

In the previous 45 editions of the Meadowlands Pace final, never have driving brothers competed against each other. That changes this year when Andrew and Todd McCarthy will battle with I Did It Myway (post 8, 10-1) and Caviart Camden (post 2, 12-1), respectively.

Brothers Howard and Jack Parker, Jr. raced in separate editions. As did Mike Allen (fourth in 1996) and brother Rod (the winner of the 1992 edition with Carlsbad Cam).

DRIVING PACE DEBUTS

Ten of the 45 winning drivers in the Meadowlands Pace were making their debuts in the race — and, of course, in the first half-dozen years of the race the majority of the drivers were making their debuts (four of first seven winners). Todd McCarthy will try the NA Cup / Meadowlands Pace Double while he's at it. No driver has won both races in the same year with two different colts. Here's a look at the winning drivers that debuted that year in the Pace:

1977 — Carl Lecause

1979 – George Sholty

1980 - Clint Galbraith

1981 – John Hayes, Jr.

1983 - Ron Waples

1987 – Trevor Ritchie

1988 - Mike Lachance

1992 - Rod Allen

1996 – George Brennan

2007 - Tim Tetrick

SPEED KILLED (THEIR CHANCES, ANYWAY)

Going too fast too early in the Meadowlands Pace happens... waaay too fast, especially.

2010 – Kyle Major posted a :25.4 opener and wound up last.

2008 — Bullville Powerful went :51.4 to the half and finished in the rear.

2001 – On The Attack paid for his :26.4 opener and trailed the field.

2000 - Tyberwood went :53.4 to the half and couldn't sustain.

1993 — Nuclear Design forced the issue a bit too much and could see 'em all late.

1978 — Race To Win took over at :28.1 but was not heard from again.

1977 — Big Towner opened in :28.4 yielded and faded. It was the first of two years that the Pace elims and final were on the same night.

EARLY 4-YEAR-OLD RESULTS NOT INDICATIVE OF FUTURE

Overheard recently, "Test Of Faith isn't as good as last year."

Obviously untrue. Yes, she is 4-for-8-but history tells us that with the really great ones, this is not an indicator of future results. Consider:

Run The Table at 3 earned \$904,000 in 1987 and was the fastest sophomore at 1:51. At 4, he lost nine of his first 10, but was, again, the fastest at 1:51.1.

Cam Fella was the Horse of the Year at 3 in 1982, but won just two of his first eight in 1983 at age 4. But, he then reeled off 28 straight to seal his second straight HOY title.

San Pail was the Horse of the Year in 2011 — at age 8. Check back to his 4-year-old season and you will find that he was 6-for-29. Then, the next three years combined, he was 39-for-55.

Matts Scooter had a 1:48.2 TT at 3 in 1988 to lower Niatross' mark. Then, at 4, he started with just six wins for his first 11. But, he quickly straightened the ship and won 17 of his last 19 to secure HOY honors at age 4 in 1989.

Moni Maker was 19-for-20 as a 3-year-old in 1996. Then at 4 she was 9-for-19. After that, she was HOY at age 5 and 6.

P.S. – In one of Test Of Faith's four defeats, she closed in :24.3. The last two Kentucky Derbies has final quarters of :25.04 and :25.67.

DELAYED GREATNESS

They raced in the Meadowlands Pace, they just weren't great, yet. Here is my top three list of stars who hadn't yet made their mark by Pace Night:

No Pan Intended was fourth in the 2003 Meadowlands Pace at 8-1. The sport's last pacing Triple Crown winner hardly a star in the early summer of 2003. But he took care of that with just a single loss from there — a second-place finish in the Windy City to All American Captor — en route to becoming the only Triple Crown winner to also win the Breeders Crown.

Red Bow Tie was ninth in the 1997 Meadowlands Pace at 4-1. William Fahy drove. RBT was later sold in the fall and then blossomed into career earnings of \$2.7 million.


Forrest Skipper competed in the 1985 Meadowlands Pace, but was not, yet, a star for Lucien Fontaine. Forrest Skipper finished the year battling Pace-winner Nihilator in the \$700G Pilgrim and served advance notice he might be the real deal in 1986. He was. He never lost again and was HOY in 1986, going 15-for-15.

MEADOWLANDS PACE QUIZ

Q. Which driver debuted in the Meadowlands Pace driving a Triple Crown winner?

A. Daniel Dube's first Pace start was in 1999 with Blissfull Hall, who finished seventh. Both driver and horse made up for that quickly. Blissfull Hall won the Triple Crown for Ben Wallace and Ron Pierce. Just a year later, Dube piloted HOY Gallo Blue Chip to a single-season record of \$2.4 million.







Pedestrian Pace?

Breeding experts David Reid and Art Zubrod give their take on the quality and potential of the Meadowlands Pace field.

More than one trainer has referred to this year's Meadowlands Pace eligibles as subpar, even questioning if there's a top stallion in the bunch.

But breeding experts David Reid and Art Zubrod aren't jumping to premature judgements.

"It's a little early to predict the depth of the class," said Reid, sales manager/director of operations for the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale. "I would say that maybe it doesn't have the potential stars at this point than in years past, but it's early in the season, and you just kind of have to wait and see what develops."

Zubrod, general manager of Brittany Farms and owner of Fair Island Farm with his wife, Leah Cheverie, thinks that less than ideal divisions happen often, if not sometimes, annually.

"There's usually one division that's weaker than normal," said Zubrod. "Some years, it's the 3-year-old trotting colts. It could be anything. I don't think it's a sign of things to come."

What makes this year a little different is that four of the preseason top colts in the division can't compete.

In early May, the reigning Dan Patch 2-year-old champ Monte Miki was retired due an injury, while just before the Pace elims, Hammering Hank, the top-ranked horse in the "Road to The Meadowlands Pace," was sidelined with a condylar fracture for an unspecified period.

"In a case like Hammering Hank, it's a good prognosis now, but how they recover and come back and perform after an injury, you never know," said Reid. "Take a horse like Always B Miki. He suffered injuries multiple years and he was able to come back and compete at a high level, but not all horses are able to do that." In addition, Pebble Beach and Gulf Shores, sons of Downbytheseaside, are ineligible due to The Meadowlands' stallion restriction condition.

"I can't keep track of 'The Gural Rule' from year to year and if they change or they don't change," said Reid. "The breeders have to take into consideration all rules I guess, and who bears the consequences and who pays the price on knowing. At the end of the day, the probable favorite for the race is ineligible."

So, does it matter that some horses aren't Pace eligible?

"You can argue that it does matter and then you could also take the counter affect, and say does the Meadowlands Pace lose some of its luster because it doesn't have all the horses eligible to the race." said Reid.

Ultimately, do breeders expect the next top stallion to be crowned off a Pace win?

"You can't take one race and pin your hopes on a stallion on that one race," said Zubrod. "For years, people stamped the Little Brown Jug [winner] as being a stallion. And they couldn't have been more wrong than that. The list of failed stallions that were Little Brown Jug winners is long. So, one race is not going to make a difference."

For those that will compete it is certainly another chance to add to their resume.

"It gives somebody an opportunity to showcase themselves," said Zubrod. "If his whole resume looks the part, they certainly should get the chance at being a stallion. Smart people aren't going to jump on a one-race career anyway. For a stallion, you want one that has shown you at least two years of good racing."

Winning the Meadowlands Pace as a favorite or a longshot but not doing anything else for the rest of the year will not get heads turning your way.

"Take [Rich Strike] the horse that won the Kentucky Derby," said Reid. "If Epicenter [the 4-1 favorite] had won there would be a lot more people trying to negotiate for Epicenter than there is for Rich Strike [the longest shot in the race at 80-1].

"He could be 99-1 and win the Meadowlands Pace but if he goes on and wins significant races at the end of the year, that goes back into the body of work for the whole year and people will make that adjustment as the year goes on."

And it isn't always about if you win or lose but how you play the game.

"Perfect Sting is a great example," said Reid. "No one was off his bandwagon, obviously. I'm sure the connections wish he would have won earlier than he did, but at the end of the year, his body of work was very, very good. So, people take that into consideration."

Pebble Beach and Gulf Shores are also ineligible to the Cane Pace for the same reasons as the Meadowlands Pace, so they will have to make their mark away from East Rutherford and the breeders will certainly be taking note.

"I would say on the pacing side, people are waiting, and I think on the trotting side, there are a few of them that people are already thinking about," said Reid. "There's no set rule, but I can confirm that it's very competitive in trying to acquire these stallions."

For Zubrod, there are all sorts of assets that he looks for.


"A horse that can leave hard, then make a move down the backside and then come home, that's what we're looking for," said Zubrod. "There are a lot of horses that are well-bred, that are extremely well conformed that have no shot at being a stallion because of how they raced, their talent level. To me,



the biggest thing is the talent level, then you've got to put the other stuff with it.

"At one time, I would have said that pedigree is so important, but you look at horses nowadays, I don't think it's quite as important to be a stallion. Somebeachsomewhere was not a horse that you would say was fashionably bred, he was just one of the greatest – if not the greatest – that I've ever seen. So, you've got to give a horse like that a shot and whatever it was that he put in them, he just keeps repeating it and repeating it until this day."









Pompey is bullish on Market Based

A dozen years ago, Chuck Pompey, Howard Taylor, and Edwin Gold partnered as owners for the first time, purchasing a female pacer named Economy Terror. After an award-winning career on the track, she became a broodmare for the trio, and on Saturday (July 16) the group will send out one of her sons, Market Based, in the \$600,000 Meadowlands Pace for 3-year-olds at The Meadowlands Racetrack.

Market Based was one of last week's two Meadowlands Pace elimination winners, along with Beach Glass. Market Based, trained by Nancy Takter, won his elim by a neck over Night Hawk thanks to a career-best 1:48.4 mile with Dexter Dunn in the sulky. Beach Glass captured his split by 5-1/4 lengths over Captain Cowboy in 1:48.1, also a lifetime best.

On Saturday, Market Based will start from post four and is 5-1 on the morning line, the third choice behind Beach Glass at 7-5 and Night Hawk at 4-1.

"It's a tough field," Pompey said. "Beach Glass was wrapped up at the end (of his mile). But you never know. We're hoping for the best. You know how it is in these races, you have to be in the right place at the right time."

Market Based's victory in his Pace elimination was his third of the season, which has seen some ups and downs. The colt went off stride in his first race of the year, a Pennsylvania Sire Stakes division at The Meadows, and then won his next two starts, a Pennsylvania All-Stars division and PASS split, both at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono.

From there, he traveled to Canada for the Pepsi North America Cup, where he finished sixth in his elimination and did not advance to the final. Two weeks later, he went to Yonkers Raceway for the eliminations of the MGM Grand Messenger Stakes, but made a break in the first turn to take himself out of contention.

Prior to his Meadowlands Pace elimination, he finished fourth in a conditioned race for 3-year-olds on July 2 at The Meadowlands.

"The last two starts have been encouraging," Pompey said. "I'm more confident going into the final now. He had some breaking issues, and I think Nancy has gotten that straightened out. I think he's on the right track now. He looked good the other night.

"He's an overachiever," Pompey added about Market Based, who has won seven of 20 lifetime starts and earned \$288,183. "He is the smallest foal Economy Terror has had. He's the smallest by far, but the most productive."

Economy Terror was a Dan Patch Award winner in 2011 at the age of 2 and earned \$1.63 million in her career.

"We had a lot of thrills with her," Pompey said. "I've got to say she's the best horse I've ever had."

Market Based, sired by Sweet Lou, is Pompey's first Meadowlands Pace finalist. Takter won the 2020 Meadowlands Pace with Tall Dark Stranger, who went on to be named the Dan Patch Award



Horse of the Year. Taylor was among the owners of Tall Dark Stranger.

"I never get too high, and I never get too low," said Pompey, who lives in northeast Pennsylvania, got hooked on harness racing at Pocono, and bought his first horse in the late 1980s. "I've been in the horse business for 34 years, and that's the way I do things. It has its ups and downs, but you appreciate the good part of it."

Pompey, who has three broodmares, enjoys the breeding side of the business.

"Especially with this one," Pompey said. "It's something special."

NIGHT HAWK READY FOR PACE NIGHT

Night Hawk, the second choice in the Meadowlands Pace, heads to the final with three wins and three seconds in seven races this season. His only off-the-board finish came in the North America Cup final, where he was fifth.

Last year, the son of Betting Line—Night Music started twice, winning both.

Night Hawk will start the Meadowlands Pace final from post three with driver David Miller. He paced his last quarter in his elimination in :25.4.

"I was happy the way he finished and raced; David was ecstatic, so I feel even better," trainer Brian Brown said. "He raced good. He behaved, sat in the hole well. He did everything he was supposed to do. If our cover would have gotten us into the stretch, I think he probably wins for sure. It didn't, that's just the way it goes."

Night Hawk is owned by Leeman Lombardo Stable, Joe Sbrocco, In The Gym Partners, and Acadia Farms.

Brown finished second in the 2017 Meadowlands Pace with Downbytheseaside, missing by a head to Huntsville, and third in the 2019 edition with Workin Ona Mystery. Night Hawk will try to deliver a trophy on Saturday.

"Other than the North America Cup, when we were sitting too far back and didn't get a chance, he's raced good every time," Brown said. "He fights and he tries. He does have high speed. I think he can grind it out too. He's got all the tools. His only bad part is he's a little goofy. He behaves on the track, but in (the paddock) he can be a little goofy at times. Other than that, he's a pretty good racehorse."


The Meadowlands Pace is race 12 on Saturday.

Working with different personalities has renewed Kennedy Stanek's passion for standardbreds

There was a time when Kennedy Stanek wasn't feeling like herself.

"Racing has had such a big impact on my life," said the standardbred groom, who works in the barn of trainer Jessica Johnson. "Before I started working for Jess at the racetrack, I was really down in the dumps, and I had lost all confidence working with the horses. But working with so many different standardbreds every day, all those different personalities, it really brought me back and renewed my passion for horses and for working with them in general."

It was a happy coincidence that led Stanek to her horse racing life.

Four years ago, she decided to test out the waters of working in standardbred racing.

"I was in my last year of high school and I was searching for a job. My best friend was looking to get started at Running Aces. So, I thought, 'What would be a good way to get a summer job and be with my best friend?' So, I went to the state fair with her and Running Aces had a booth in the horse barn with standardbred horses. I talked to the lady there, who happened to be [trainer] Jessica Johnson and I said, 'I think I'd like to work for you.' She told me she was looking for someone."


Stanek still wanted to take some time to mull over her decision.

That's got to be my favorite part of the job, It's so relaxing.

Kennedy Stanek also breeds dairy goats.

It was another conversation that gave her the clarity she was looking for.

"I can't help but credit A.J. [Alyssa Joy Fetterly], who was working at a feed store. I wasn't quite committed to working at Running Aces at that point, but she gave me Jessica's number and really convinced me to work there. Once I started, which was four years ago, I was hooked."

Stanek has no regrets about her career choice.

In fact, working with the standardbreds has been a game changer for her.

"It makes you feel really important when you're coming in each day to feed them breakfast and they are all looking at you like, 'Hey, give me some attention.' They are all amazing. They really do make you feel happy and content."

Take, for example, Alilthundadownunda and Teachmehowtotory.

Her affinity for both, Alilthundadownunda, a 4-year-old pacing son of Malak Uswaad N—Wild About Eagle, and Teachmehowtotory, a 5-year-old trotting daughter of Braggart—Rails of Victory, is obvious the moment she mentions their names.

"Teachmehowtotory is just so fun to watch and work with. She's awesome. Alilthundadownunda, he is just a wonderful horse. Watching them and any horses you are connected to when they race... it's so hard to put in words. It's truly exhilarating. Every time you watch them, every horse, it's just so exciting. When you get them in the barn and you start working with them, they become a part of your life and they are very important to you."

The horses also have a certain quality Stanek has come to truly appreciate.

And although they can't talk the talk, the horse can be great sounding boards, she noted.

"I talk to the horses all the time, especially Alilthundadownunda. When he was younger, he needed a bit of encouragement in the paddock, so we talk all the time. He's a great listener."

The most rewarding and treasured part of Stanek's connection to the pacers and trotters is when she gets the opportunity to sit in the race bike.

Whatever the weather, she's in her happy place.

"Occasionally, I'll jog horses. That's got to be my favorite part of the job, It's so relaxing. Everything comes together and it feels



like a great time, where there is no stress, only that enjoyment of being in that moment with the horse. It could be raining out and I still love it. Rain or shine, I'm happy to be there."

Stanek is also happy to have another rewarding, animalfocused job outside of racing.

Along with her sister, she tends to a unique group of four-legged creatures.

"My sister and I also breed dairy goats, so that's very time consuming. About eight years ago, we bought a couple of dairy goats. We were just going to try it out and see how we felt about it. We've kept on showing them through 4H and the American Dairy Goat Association. We're not quite great at it yet, but we have a nice herd.

Do goats and standardbreds happen to share anything in common?

According to Stanek, the answer is yes.

"They are both pretty wily and every day is an adventure. They absolutely have their own personalities. They are all individuals and they expected to be treated like it."

As for what lies ahead, career-wise, for Stanek, the answer isn't quite clear for now.

The one certainty, however, is that she will always have some association with standardbreds.

"I would love to train one day, but I'm a pre-vet student, so who knows, maybe I'll be a vet at the racetrack one day. It's hard to say for sure. I also actually own two riding horses. I'm trying to get into versatility ranch horse showing, but it's very complicated and there is so much to learn. I suppose there is a lot to look forward to, but I don't know quite what it will look like at this point. These standardbreds just have a way of drawing you in. They are beautiful, they are amazing to work with, and they make your life better."

For the time being, Stanek is happy to stay in the moment, grateful for the chance to work with the horses, and thrilled to be part of their lives.

It's why she forward to the moment she takes the final steps before reaching the barn, anticipating the reaction she is about to receive from the faces that peer out at her from the front of their stalls.

"All of the horses are happy to see me in the morning. It's nice to walk around and give every one of them their equal share of love and pats. That's a really nice thing to have in my life.







Big races on tap this weekend in Finland and Sweden

Mikkeli in Finland and Årjäng in Sweden will draw attention from European harness racing fans this weekend.

The \$140,000 St Michel-Ajo over the mile in Mikkeli is one of the summer's highlights in Finland and the track was once known as the world's fastest 5/8 mile tracks, similar to The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono in the United States. The field in Mikkeli is not quite as strong as we are used to seeing in the Finnish woods, but still, the mile will be raced and a classical winner will be crowned.

Sunday (July 17) is the race date for St Michel-Ajo.

The day before, Årjäng plays host to the track's biggest race. The \$113,000 Årjängs Stora Sprinterlopp is on the schedule and the winner receives a ticket to Jägersro's \$285,000 Hugo Åbergs Memorial (July 26), a race to which some great horses already have been invited.



Don Fanucci Zet, winner of the Elitloppet in 2021, is set for Hugo Åbergs Memorial and Daniel Redén's 6-year-old will be seen among nine opponents in Saturday's race in Årjäng, as well.

Behind him, title defender Vernissage Grif, trained and driven by Alessandro Gocciadoro, will try to repeat last year's triumph, this time from post 10.

Jason Bartlett made the most of his visit Monday afternoon (July 11) at Monticello Raceway, scoring a win in a New York Sire Stakes and one Excelsior event for sophomore trotting colts. He also picked up two winning catch drives to give him a Grand Slam on the afternoon card. He scored in four consecutive races.

The first heat of NYSS, which was already a short field, was whittled even more with the scratch of Middleman, making it a three-horse contest. **Chapheart** was slowly grinding his way to the front end in the middle of the first turn when Castle House, the betting favorite, rolled off his feet, made a break, and knocked himself out of contention. Trond Smedshammer, driving Chapheart, controlled the tempo for the remainder of the race. Jordan Stratton, aboard Velvet Style, caught up to

Chapheart and as they hit the 1:29.2, Velvet Style pulled and sat outside of Chapheart the entire way to the wire, but was unable to catch the leader, who tripped the beam in 1:58.1. The win for Chapheart was his second in NYSS company this season for winning owner Purple Haze Stable and pushed the son of Chapter Seven to over \$100,000 in earnings this year. He is also trained by Smedshammer.

The second division was also a short field of just five. Bartlett went down the road in a wire-to-wire three-length win in 1:58.4 aboard **Quincy Market**. It was the second win on the season for the Nicholas Devita trainee. The 2-5 favorite, Tantra Blue Chip, made a break at the 5/8 marker and took himself out of contention. Perfect Titan (Jordan Stratton) was second, followed by Grands Spa (Jim Taggart Jr.).

In Excelsior action, Dan Daley won with **Grey Clouds** in a wire-to-wire score in 1:58.1, paying \$11.60. The son of Chapter Seven is owned by Ann-Mari & Jared Dailey. It was his third win of the season. With Bartlett driving, Makadushin N Cheeze (Conway Hall) made short work in the second heat, scoring a four-length win in 1:58.3. It was the first of four consecutive wins for Bartlett. For Makadushin N Cheese, it was his fifth win on the year for trainer David Dewhurst.

Beltassima remains undefeated; Gingras wins three at Oak Grove

On Tuesday (June 12) **Beltassima** and Andrew McCarthy never had an anxious moment as the prohibitive favorite splashed home in the \$50,000 fourth leg of the 4-year-old series at Oak Grove Racing, Gaming & Hotel for trotting mares. The other three divisions for Kentucky-breds were also captured by the public's post time choice. Driver Yannick Gingras was in the sulky behind three of the four winners.

Beltassima entered this contest with an unblemished three-forthree record this season and established she has a fondness for the Bluegrass by collecting her fourth consecutive triumph. The daughter of Trixton—Beltane Hanover assumed command from her rail position in the beginning of the mile with second choice Awesome Trix and Tony Hall in second. The order remained the same at the finish line with Jazzy Jules and Christian Lind in third.

Trained by Tony Alagna and owned by Crawford Farms, Beltassima is now 25 11-4-2 and has earned \$422,947. The mare paid \$2.20 to win and stopped the clock in 1:55.1 over a rain-soaked track.

Blue Diamond Eyes provided Yannick Gingras with his first of three victories on the card when the daughter of Captaintreacherous—Aria Hanover powered home in 1:50.4 in the division for pacing mares. The was the fourth consecutive triumph for the Kentucky champion after a slow start to begin her season. High Minded and Kevin Wallis were second with Classicist and Andrew McCarthy in third.

Trained by Ron Burke, Blue Diamond Eyes now sports a resume of 39 15-7-5 and has banked \$1.25 million for owners Thomas and Scott Dillon. The mare paid \$2.10 to her supporters and like Beltassima has won all four legs of this series.



Kentucky champion **Goldie's Legacy** collected his third win of the series. Steered by Gingras, the son of Always A Virgin—Ag-n-au Bluegrass took lead before the half-mile pole and never relinquished it in the division for male pacers. Komodo Beach and Andrew McCarthy finished second with Caviart Lotus and Tony Hall in Third.

Trained by Jeff Cullipher, Goldie's Legacy now has earned \$464,910 for co-owners Pollack Racing and his trainer. The gelding's record stands at 47 16-4-2. He paid \$3.40 to win as the heavy favorite and was timed in 1:50.



I waited for him to get his feet underneath him and pressed on to the front. He's super-nice, and he has three lungs. We're just hoping he still loves his job every week. He's a chestnut; I hope nobody tells him that."

The son of International Moni—Peach Martini had little trouble repelling the first-over challenge of Southwind Distilld, downing him by 3 lengths in 1:56.2. Herodotus earned show.

Megan Scran trains Crantini for Thestable Crantini Group.

Kenobi scored a front-end, maiden-breaking victory in 1:57.3, thwarting a sustained uncovered challenge by Spitfire Oversees. Drive To Deliver was second, a length back, with Sinatra De Vie third. Winning driver Tim Tetrick said the point was not necessarily where he wanted to be.

"Last week he ran going to the gate because he threw his head," Tetrick said. "He started doing it again, so I just turned him loose. He's really no good on the lead; he just goes to sleep. He wasn't

very brave out there today, but I kept pecking at him and talking to him. He's meant to be a nice horse. I think he'll be a much better 3-year-old because he's like a big kid now."

"Listen," he said, "it's always fun to win. I'm real happy. I can't take much credit. Anthony sends them here, and they're good to go.

Of the trio, Austral Hanover was most impressive, powering to the top at the quarter and crushing the field by 6-3/4 lengths in a career-best 1:57.2. Lookintogetlucky and Alonso rounded out the ticket.

"I think he's on the cusp of breaking through to the sires stakes," Twaddle said. "In fact, we discussed putting him there and trying him, but we opted for the more conversative route to let him develop. Anthony is very patient. He lets them let him know when it's time."

Aaron Merriman records 14,000th career win

Aaron Merriman, who ranks fifth on North America's all-time win list, collected career victory 14,000 Wednesday (July 13) at The Meadows. The milestone win came with Maching Me Zilly in race 10. Merriman notched 14,001 the very next race.

Milestones and awards have been coming fast and furious for Merriman, 43, a native of Cuyahoga Falls, OH and harness racing's seven-time reigning dash champion whose mounts have won more than \$98.5 million. In fact, it's been only a little over 13 months since he recorded career win 13,000. Although he recorded his first win in 1998, more than half his victories have come since 2014, testament to Merriman's talent and breakneck schedule as he drives at both The Meadows and Ohio tracks.

Merriman has been trying to reduce that grind; the figures show that he has, although modestly. He had 4,397 starts in 2021 but is on pace for about 4,200 this year.

"I'm trying to cut 10 per cent per year and make sure I take one day off per week," he says. "That's very important to me. I'm definitely a day-to-day guy, but I would like to take a week or two off the beginning of next year. The road is definitely tiring me. Harness racing has given me so much, but it's taken something from me, too."

Asked what has helped him achieve such great success, Merriman pointed to his ability to compartmentalize, to keep his professional and personal lives apart in his mind and approach.

"I don't hold grudges at the track, don't carry them race to race, don't get mad at people," he says. "There may be little wars on the track, but I don't get involved in them. I want to do the best I can for every person I drive for. It wouldn't be fair to my owners or trainers to get involved with that other stuff."

Still, Merriman allows that this milestone, this year, is more meaningful.

"I've had a tough year personally, with my mom being sick. So this one does feel a little different."

But he also offered:

"Every race is a milestone to me. Each race means something to

somebody. People count on us, so I always have to try my best and bring my best attitude — even if I have to fake it."

Also not to be missed is Sandalwood, a Bettor's Delight filly and first foal from multiple 2-year-old stakes-winning filly Key West p,2,1:51.1.
