A change of Pace

Saturday marks the first time the Meadowlands Pace will be broadcast on Fox Sports 2 in association with the New York Racing Association. The hope is it will be the first of a long, fruitful relationship getting harness racing broader TV exposure.

For the first time, the Meadowlands Pace will be part of a two-hour live show on Fox Sports 2 (FS2) from 8-10 p.m. on Saturday (July 17).

The New York Racing Association (NYRA) televises thoroughbred action from Saratoga and Belmont regularly on FS2 and it's The Meadowlands' connections with NYRA that led to the Pace broadcast.

"Dave O'Rourke and Jeff [Gural] have a friendly business relationship," said Eric Donovan, NYRA's senior director of TV broadcast operations. "Jeff knows what we do with our broadcasts on Fox. So, the idea was floated to have The Meadowlands Pace on Fox."

O'Rourke, the president and chief executive officer of NYRA, and Gural, the president and chief executive officer of The Meadowlands, had discussions for the possibility of a Pace show in 2020, but with the pandemic it never moved beyond that phase until ideas resurfaced for this year.

"NYRA is a perfect fit quite honestly for The Meadowlands because of the relationship that we have with them," said Jason Settlemoir, Meadowlands' chief operating officer and general manager. "They do a great job. And we think it only makes sense to try and get this audience involved and get us on TV. That's



always been something that Jeff and I have wanted to do, is put us in front of more people on television. We're excited about the opportunity on Saturday and the opportunities going forward."

NYRA just signed an agreement with Fox Sports television that extends through 2030 for daily racing coverage from Belmont and Saratoga. As the top track in North America, if not the world, it only makes sense for The Meadowlands to be interested in getting a TV deal of their own.

"I would love to see The Meadowlands get tied into something similar to what NYRA does on a daily basis," said Settlemoir. "But we'll have to see how everything goes and how things work and maybe this would be something that would be, as long as things go well, something that could be explored since they race in the afternoon and we race at night."

Even though this will be a NYRA production, it will be produced and directed by people with harness racing backgrounds and will feature The Meadowlands talent that everyone knows.

NYRA's point person for Saturday will be the show's producer, Kim French, who grew up going to races at The Syracuse Mile from the age of 4.

"Once we got wind that this show was going to happen this year, we knew that Kim would be the perfect person to kind of tie it together because she has the knowledge of our television production environment plus the knowledge of harness racing," said Donovan.

French, an assistant director and production manager for NYRA, has worked in television for 15 years and done countless broadcasts, including The Breeders' Cup and Kentucky Derby.

"Kimberly is an asset, that's for certain," said Settlemoir. "We got lucky that she went to work for NYRA. She obviously has a lot of background in harness racing, so for NYRA to be able to lean on Kim, and for us to be able to lean on Kim, too, works out great because she has that background."

French has been dedicated to harness racing throughout her career and has been a freelance harness writer for more than a decade and is the current editor of The Midwest News Report.

What many may not know is that French was put on the path to TV production as a college student while attending the Clyde Hirt Journalism Workshop, which is sponsored by the U.S. Harness Writers Association.

"Because it is the first show of this nature, essentially, I'm the go-between, between my organization and The Meadowlands,"





said French. "So, what I do is apply my knowledge of harness racing and work at both ends to reach our goal, which is to promote harness racing to people that have not been introduced to it so that they can become fans or at least knowledgeable about the sport. That is the whole goal of this broadcast."

Working alongside French will be NYRA's long-time television director Mitch Levites, who has done harness racing TV for Yonkers Raceway and New York City Off-Track Betting.

"Mitch loves horse racing," said Donovan. "He loves the thoroughbreds and he loves the people around it, but I think his first love really was harness racing. How he got into racing was going to Roosevelt [as a kid]."

The Meadowlands dynamic duo of Dave Brower and Hall of Famer Dave Little will be doing pre- and post-race commentary. The



entertaining and engaging Jessica Otten will be handling pre-race features and paddock interviews. Gabe Prewitt will be looking to "Send It In" with winner's circle reactions, and the ultra-consistent "Voice of The Meadowlands", Ken Warkentin, will handle the announcing assignment on a stakes-filled 14-race card.

The Pace is scheduled to go off at 9:46 p.m. and will be the final race shown on the broadcast that will also include the Dorothy Haughton Memorial, William R. Haughton Memorial and E.T. Gerry Jr. Hambletonian Maturity.

"Our executive producer, Tony Allevato, his mantra from day one is the three things you want to aim to do on our shows is to educate, inform and entertain," said Donovan. "So, you have those goals for each show whether it's a Thursday at Aqueduct or The Meadowlands Pace or the Travers. You want to be able to captivate that audience because to gain new fans and new viewers, you have to be able to tell the stories. We are fans of this sport and this sport can't exist forever with just us, we need to bring in new people so we need to have these kinds of elements on the show.

"I think it's a great opportunity for both NYRA and The Meadowlands and for Fox Sports and the fans of racing, not only harness racing but all racing. I think the more racing that's out there, the better it is for both breeds."



Pacing yourself on the Meadowlands Pace wagering-laden program

"If you want to be a good archeologist you've got to get out of the library," said Indiana Jones (from a screenplay by G. Lucas, J. Nathanon and D. Koepp).

With a tweak or two, it is also fine advice for wagering behavior on any pari-mutuel programs. Horse players spend too much time in the library of handicapping and not enough time out in the field where positive betting action is an acquired talent.

Bettors Banquet (BB) returns after the pandemic hiatus with its stronger messages based upon smart wagering practices and the bottom-line rule to strengthen profiting from pari-mutuels: make decisions, not selections.

This Saturday at The Meadowlands the program is adorned with once-a-year stakes events, but the betting menu blankets the card as it does for every program. It becomes quiet in the handicapping library but it's a din out in the field. That means instead of choosing and measuring their wagers, most harness players will be betting with both fists, as the saying goes, and all learned in the library surrenders what powers it may have to the unpredictable phenomenon that causes an event to result one way or the other. Yes, luck is in control.

This Saturday, I will leave the library with definite plans for my wagering action and let luck behave as it may. With no exceptions I will play or pass any bet that does not live up to my expectations. A full example is my personal odds line for the Meadowlands Pace (MP):

My odds are based upon my opinions were this race to happen 100 times. I will not bet any horse which I assign odds of more than 6-1 (to account for the margin of error) so here I have four contenders.

The points beyond the process are this: find contenders in a race and assign them odds. If your odds are better than the public's odds you have a win bet and when you have a win bet (only when one or two of your contenders odds are better than the public's odds) you can plan exotic wagers around it.

The wagering public decides which races to bet. Before I go into the field I am in the library choosing races that I feel I can estimate better than the public.

If the work I do in the library is accurate, my field results have a good chance for success. No wagers are wasted, as in playing multi-race exotics where you add horses "in case" your contenders fail. The July 17 lineup of stakes on the Meadowlands Pace program is a terrific romp outside of the library — if you can get out in time, because more than the volume of high-class races available are the tests of wagering prowess they offer. These are not easy races in which to make a personal odds line and due to that they demand intense interpretation; maybe too much for the work involved. We won't choose our poison; we will pass for the races that support stronger decisions. (We offer our contenders assigned odds of 6-1 or under — the only we would wager upon.)

Both Stanley Dancer Memorial divisions receive our opinions expressed in odds. In the first division, we make Take All Comers (4-1) the alternate for backing Dancinginthedark M, who we quess will be an unacceptable priced favorite.


In the second division, we make Venerate a prohibitive favorite and make the other Love Me-bred colt, Rattle My Cage, 5-1.

Due to the deadline of this BB edition, we need to be back in the library to determine how we evaluate personal odds lines on the other races. Certainly, we are already aware there are races we are not interested in playing but for those we are attracted to for betting purposes, we must write an odds line.

Which races we choose, of course, will affect our dismissal or acceptance of taking on multi-race exotics. In future BBs we will explain how best to play Pick 3s through Pick 6s, so be ready to battle about those rules, since we address them with rules that are not popular.

Meadowlands Pace Night is one for the ages


The \$700,000 Meadowlands Pace is the crown jewel of "The Greatest Night In Harness Racing", a claim substantiated by the fact that over the course of the 14-race extravaganza 130 horses — including eight of those ranked in the Hambletonian Society/Breeders Crown weekly Top Ten poll — with total earnings well in excess of \$50 million will compete for over \$2.5 million in purses.

Pace night is Saturday, July 17 and will begin with an early post time of 6 p.m. The Meadowlands Pace, Hambletonian Maturity and both the Dorothy and WR Haughton Memorial stakes will be televised live in a joint effort with New York Racing Association (NYRA) as a part of the popular "America's Day At The Races" series on Fox Sports 2 from 8 to 10 p.m. These four races constitute a special "Fox Sports 2 Stakes Pick 4" on races 6-9 with a \$125,000 Guarantee.

The Big M's TV team of Dave Brower and Dave Little will be at the desk spearheading the broadcast with Jessica Otten handling back paddock and training center interviews with some of the primary contenders. The voice of The Meadowlands, track announcer Ken Warkentin, will call his fifth Pace, while Gabe Prewitt, veteran race caller at Pompano Park and Lexington's Red Mile and director of racing at Caesars Entertainment, will join the team and handle winner's circle interviews.

The Meadowlands Pace became an instant classic when Escort won the inaugural for a purse of \$425,000, the largest ever offered at the time. The roster of past champions includes the legendary Niatross (1980) and his greatest son Nihilator (1985), the iron tough Captaintreacherous (2013) and Tall Dark Stranger's thrilling rally back to victory after being headed just last year. It remains an absolute on the resume of those who aspire to greatness in the pacing world.

Last week's elimination races yielded a pair of **surprising winners**. Southwind Gendry, driven perfectly by Yannick Gingras for trainer Ron Burke who owns the Always B Miki gelding with Phil Collura, Knox Services, J&T Silva and Purnell & Libby, got a soft middle three-eighths then sprinted home



in :25.3 making catching him impossible. His backers were rewarded with a generous \$22 return on a \$2 wager.

Hellabalou (whose win payoff of \$165.60 was the largest in Pace history) was put in play early by driver Andrew McCarthy who called an audible at the start when he observed that none to his inside were pushing off the gate hard. That resulted in a great trip behind the favorite, which the Sweet Lou colt converted into an unexpected victory for trainer Eddie Dennis and owner Erik Good.

Both beaten favorites, Perfect Sting and One Eight Hundred, will seek redemption on Saturday, both clearly possess the talent to win the biggest race of their career.

The list of supporting stakes on the evening's menu is an imposing one, led by the \$400,000 E. T. Gerry, Jr. Hambletonian Maturity. This stake for 4-year-old trotters will pit the winner of last year's Hambletonian, Ramona Hill, with Andrew McCarthy in his customary position behind the Muscle Hill mare for trainer Tony Alagna and the ownership group of Brad Grant, Crawford Farms Racing, Robert LeBlanc and John Fodera and Steve Wienick as In The Gym Partners against the winner of the 2020 Hambletonian Oaks, Sorella and her formidable team of Meadowlands leading driver Dexter Dunn and the 2020 Trainer of the Year, Nancy Takter who labor for owners Brent and Elmer Fannin and Al and Michelle Crawford's racing division in a talent laden field of a dozen at a mile and one-eighth.

The filly companion stake to the Meadowlands Pace is the \$174,400 Mistletoe Shalee, sponsored by Odds On Racing & Best Bets Stable, where the currently unbeaten princess of the pace, Hot Mess Express (McCarthy), will bring her act back to town after having an easy time with her Indiana rivals over the last month. Tony Alagna trains the Panther Hanover lass for University of Kentucky basketball legend Sam Bowie.

The \$530,000 WR Haughton FFA Pace, Sponsored by Winbak Farms, drew no fewer than 20 of the fastest standard-bred gunslingers in the business and will be raced as two ultra-competitive fields of 10. Among those competing in the Haughton will be This Is The Plan (Gingras), currently sitting at #1 in the Hambletonian Society/Breeders Crown Top Ten poll. He races out of the Ron Burke barn for Burke Racing, Weaver Bruscemi, J&T Silva and Purnell & Libby.

The \$178,500 companion race for mares, memorializing Mrs. Dorothy Haughton, sponsored by David and Mary Ellen McDuffee, will pit 11 of the fastest females in the game with current division queen Lyons Sentinel hampered by the extreme outside post. Driver Tim Tetrick tricked them all back in May when he engineered a cover trip from a bad post and caught everyone, including the betting public, napping as she returned a \$43 winning mutuel. She has had the favorite's target on her back ever since and responded with a forwardly placed world record tour de force in the Artiscape for trainer Jim King, Jr and Threelyonsracing.

The Miss Versatility, raced for a mere \$40,000, would be

the feature on just about any race card as it renews one of harness racing's most entertaining and enduring rivalries in racing between the great 6-year-old trotting mares Atlanta (Gingras/Burke) and Manchego (Dunn/Takter). Manchego, owned by Barry Guariglia's Black Horse Racing, has a slight edge in earnings at \$2,871,152 over Crawford Farms Racing, Brad Grant and Howard Taylor's Atlanta at \$2,792,973 while Atlanta holds a 7-5 edge in winning heads up matches.

With the \$1 million **Hambletonian** just three weeks off, the trotting faithful will get a last look at the top players for those in the \$273,000 (div) Stanley Dancer Memorial, sponsored by Tattersalls.

Dancinginthedark M (Tetrick), a Menhammar Stuteri homebred son of Readly Express trained by Marcus Melander, is one misstep away from a perfect season and caught a friendly spot in the first division, a short field of six. Division two is loaded, with Breeders Crown champ On A Streak with Dan Dube driving for trainer Luc Blais and owner Determination. They will face as pretty a pair of trotting colts as you'll ever see in Pennsylvania Sires Stakes (PASS) final winner Captain Corey, who gets Yannick Gingras for the first time for trainer Ake Svanstedt and partners SRF Stable, Knutsson Trotting and Midnight Sun Partners along with the enigmatic New Jersey Sires Stakes (NJSS) final runner-up D Farms Cuatro De Julio, driven by Lucas Wallin for trainer Marie Ortolan Bar. They join Dan Patch 2020 freshman and Mohawk Million winner Venerate, driven by Andy Miller for trainer/wife Julie and partners Pinske Stables.

The fillies will prep for the Hambletonian Oaks with the \$282,000 Del Miller, sponsored by Pollack Racing, and an evenly matched group it is. Beltassima (McCarthy/Alagna for Crawford Farms Racing) currently sits atop the division with wins in the NJSS final and Reynolds, she seems to have caught the easier division. Iteration, driven by Brian Sears for trainer Melander and owner Courant, Inc who has been dominant in the NY program, heads up division two where she will find plenty of adversity from the likes of last year's Breeders Crown winner Lady Chaos, Dave Miller for trainer Linda Toscano and owners Gutnick, Pontone, Lozito and Enviro Stables and 2020 Doherty Memorial winner Darlene Hanover driven by Scott Zeron for Yankeeland Farms and trainer Brett Bittle in a very deep field.

There will be all the action you can imagine at The Meadowlands on Saturday complete with popular local food trucks and the highly sought-after Pace T-shirts return this year. **Free programs** are available for the entire card, as they are every night of racing. Track handicapper Dave Brower, who will host the festivities, offers his **insight and selections** on the web, as does race caller **Ken Warkentin**.

Handicapping the Meadowlands Pace card

My picks for Saturday's (July 17) rich stakes card at The Meadowlands.

Race 1 — Del Miller Memorial \$142,000

DONNA SOPRANO fought on gamely through the stretch last out when she fended off an early pocket pull from BELTAS-SIMA in losing ultimately to only the 3-5 favorite. Mohawk Million runner-up from last year goes for a sharp barn when they come to the Meadowlands. BELTASSIMA rebounded last week in the Reynolds to reach off a second-over trip following a period in the race where she was briefly three-wide; New Jersey Sires Stakes (NJSS) champ was perhaps a bit overused two back. ALTAR was last year's NJSS champion at 2 and is new to Takter's barn this year. That qualifier against Ramona Hill was an improvement and is more than capable if they've figured out the June breaking problems. FLAWLESS COUNTRY was just fair last out. After not being worse than second in 9 starts last year she's been no better than third in 4 starts this year.

Picks: Altar, Donna Soprano, Beltassima

Race 2 — Stanley Dancer Memorial \$135,500

DANCINGINTHEDARK M brushed to the lead past the quarter in a driving rainstorm last week and never looked back. Tetrick chased after him a bit towards the end of that mile but it didn't look like the outcome was ever in serious doubt; looks to control it once again starting from the rail. TAKE ALL COMERS was used early before being forced to yield and gave game chase through the stretch while being miles clear of everyone else; not out of the question as the main threat to the favorite. ZENITH STRIDE somehow shocked here last year but hasn't been able to replicate that since; gave way last week from the pocket. BROOKVIEW BOLT has gone some big miles at Indiana over the past couple of

seasons; comes East for Burke as the only horse in here not Hambletonian-eligible.

Picks: Take All Comers, Dancinginthedark M, Tangled Love

Race 3 — Del Miller Memorial \$139,500

DARLENE HANOVER was strong here last week when racing first-over and a similar try would give her an honest chance against these. Like many others here, she's trying to work her way back into last year's freshmen form. LADY CHAOS is an extremely consistent type and brings class with her; one more inch and she would have had second two back and exits a game try on the front. HOT AS HILL also was brave on the front last week but now moves to the outside. YOU ATO DREAM couldn't get involved last out from post 10 but she's better than that; will be more prominent here at a price. ITERATION has banked a lot in her career in New York; MAZ-ZARATI's best would give her an upset chance.

Picks: You Ato Dream, Darlene Hanover, Lady Chaos

Race 4 - Mistletoe Shalee \$174,400

The HOT MESS EXPRESS rolls into the Meadowlands for her local debut, though she did qualify here to be second to Perfect Sting in early June. A standout in Indiana, she beat open company including the PA-sired GRACE HILL last out

in the Nadia Lobell to run her unbeaten streak to five on the year. GRACE HILL wasn't bad to be second to the fast Test Of Faith here two back and then closed well enough up the inside once the passing lane became available last out at Hoosier; may only need a clearer shot early. Last year's Dan Patch champ FIRE START HANOVER looks to get things on track. For what it's worth Dunn chose this one over #4. NOTO-RIOUS PINK put up a monster qualifier two back but it didn't translate in an actual race last out. BLUE DIAMOND EYES and CONTINUALOU will both offer prices for Burke; the latter is better than her last two races show.

Picks: Grace Hill, Continualou, Hot Mess Express

Race 5 — Miss Versatility \$40,000

This is the lowest purse of any stakes offered on the night but renews the MANCHEGO and ATLANTA rivalry for the fifth year. MANCHEGO comes off a surprising loss in the Crawford Farms but I guess what do you expect having to come first over into a :56.3 half. Gingras was quoted last week as saying that ATLANTA has never been better, and she's simply mowed them down with a relentless grind in each of her two races this year. WHEN DOVESCRY continues to get away with kindly rating on the front end but hasn't had enough to stave off Atlanta, an obvious part of the mix once again. WESLYNN QUEST closed willingly last out and it came on the barn change to Engblom; capable of speed if McCarthy wants it.

Race 6 — Dorothy Haughton Memorial \$178,500

LYONS SENTINEL brushed and took them all the way two weeks ago in a lifetime best 1:48 mile. She's definitely the "best" of these but will need to overcome post 10; hard to believe she was 20-1 five back from a similar position. GIA'S SURREAL took a first-over run at the big favorite last week in her first start over the track and did well for herself to sustain and hold second. With the posts now reversed so could the order of finish; issue though is a far shorter price. PEAKY SNEAKY tried a wide move last out from an impossible spot. Seems due to show something though I'm somewhat surprised that Gingras opted instead for WARRAWEE UBEAUT. I thought that KEEP ROCKIN A would have been better last out and never got involved; at least the price will be enticing should she fire. JK FIRST LADY saved ground last out and had late pace once angled late. HEN PARTY is talented but makes her first start since November.

Picks: Lyons Sentinel, Keep Rockin A, Peaky Sneaky

Race 7 — William Haughton Memorial \$265,400

Like most races on this card, what a competitive bunch this is. ANGERS BAYAMA is one of a few here in raging form. After flying two back with that amazing last quarter, he almost lasted in the Roll With Joe despite facing heavy pressure on the front through fast fractions. His morning line of 6-1 seems about reasonable though a few ticks higher would be even better. BACKSTREET SHADOW came with an ill-fated try for the front last out and in the process was dueled into defeat along with STARS ALIGN A; prior to that the former won in 1:47.3. RUTHLESS HANOVER broke stride last out as the favorite in the \$250,000 Graduate; looks like he got jammed up a bit when that happened. All races prior to that are excellent. CENTURY FARROH raced well last out in his return to the Meadowlands, showing speed and then clearly moving fastest of all late. CATCH THE FIRE is doing well with his dual racing and breeding; invades from Scioto in career best form though this will be a tall task.

Picks: Backstreet Shadow, Angers Bayama, Century Farroh

Race 8 — Hambletonian Maturity \$400,000

READY FOR MONI finally got the better of IT'S ACADEMIC last week and it took a second-over trip to get the job done. That was a nice drive that Tetrick worked out from post 8 and the \$15 win price was a solid overlay. Can certainly win again though he'll have to overcome the second-tier in a 12-horse field. Also in the second-tier is chief rival IT'S ACADEMIC. He's raced exclusively on the front in all his recent races but I suspect he doesn't have to be there to win. RAMONA HILL qualified

well following a rare miscue at the start in the Joie De Vie; a bit of a wild card but can jump up and win this if on her game. Fellow 4-year-old mare HYPNOTIC AM was brave last out in wearing down It's Academic only to lose to the tripped out Ready For Moni; another that would be no shock and it's interesting that the morning line favors the horses over the mares. BEADS threw in a puzzler last out. He broke in the stretch but he was gapped off cover almost the entire race prior to that; would need a total bounce back. NEXT LEVEL STUFF has won the last two times she drew the rail; can grab a share.

Picks: Hypnotic AM, Ready For Moni, Ramona Hill

Race 9 — Meadowlands Pace Final \$700,000

For as unusual as last week's eliminations were in terms of the respective impossible and less than likely results, both of which came off largely single-file racing, they raised more questions than answers heading into the Pace final. Sears won this race in 2019 with Best In Show and I'll take an upset stab with CHASE H HANOVER in a race that's really up for grabs. Fast last year at 2, he could be rounding into his better form right now. Following a first-over attempt in the Messenger final, he had a lot of pace last week when Sears took him to the inside only to get caught behind a tiring leader and then having to angle again for a seam. ONE EIGHT HUNDRED was a surprise last week. He had it his own way on the front and you could tell he was in trouble the way the CHARLIE MAY took it to him around the final turn, maybe it was just the sloppy going? SOUTHWIND GENDRY was allowed to be left alone on the lead last week in his elimination and he made them pay, lasting all the way in 1:49.1 as a 10-1 upsetter. 2-year-old champ PERFECT STING did all he could do last week by closing in :25.1, only asked to pace for his final quarter. No issue in that circumstance of not being able to get to the race winner but he was still held off for second by LAWLESS SHADOW, who outraced his odds coming into his elimination from Canada. AMERICAN COURAGE was all the rage and rightfully so, but he didn't seem at his best either last week and now moves all the way out to post 10. At least will offer a square price. CHARLIE MAY has raced so well

in all his recent East coast starts and it's too bad he doesn't yet have a win to show for it; would have to think Brett Miller will be sending him early. HELLABALOU pulled off the 80-1 shocker in his elimination last week when changing back to McCarthy and getting the trip. He did outsprint the top two late, so you have to give him credit for that.

Picks: Chase H Hanover, One Eight Hundred, Perfect Sting

Race 10 – William Haughton Memorial \$265,400

In another highly competitive division of the William Haughton, WORKIN ONA MYSTERY was far more ready than I thought he'd be last out. When making his first start back at the Meadowlands just his 13th over the past two seasons, he showed a ton of early speed, encountered stretch traffic and squeezed through a seam too late in the shadow of the wire. The Brian Brown trainee can win. THIS IS THE PLAN rates as the programmed favorite but he needed every inch of that perfect trip to get up in the Roll With Joe. That's not to say he can't win again but the price may be too short to try. CATTLEWASH was impressive last week in the Graduate final leaving into a hot pace and then somehow being able to track down the pocket sitter when it didn't look like he was going to reach with 100 yards to go. LEONIDAS A makes his second start for Gregory and moves to the big track; possible price play. SHAKE THAT HOUSE is known for some big miles from time to time and he was well respected at the windows against similar two back; will now be overlooked but is a possibility. CHIEF MATE had solid late pace last out and a possible bomb if the race sets up for him.

Picks: Workin Ona Mystery, Shake That House, Cattlewash

Race 11 — Stanley Dancer Memorial \$138,000

Last year's 2-year-old division winner VENERATE rebounded last week at the Meadowlands following a break two back to win impressively in the off-going with a :26.3 final quarter. SONOFAMISTERY almost lasted on the front end in his most recent, but he was going to be beaten by VENERATE regardless of that break at the wire. That said, he still brings a lot of speed with him. ON A STREAK won last year's Breeders Crown but hasn't come back as fast yet this year. CUATRO DE JULIO showed a load of talent last year; in the process of piecing it together this year in hopes of Hambletonian like many of these. CAPTAIN COREY dominated PASS foes two back and would have done so again if not for the recent break; gets tested once again with these types. RATTLE MY CAGE steps up.

Meadowlands Pace doings then and now - edition #45

- 1. George Segal debuted in the Meadowlands Pace in 1978 finishing fourth with Brittany Rd. Marty Granoff was also fourth in the 1986 Pace with free-legged Masquerade, who would later capture the Breeders Crown at Garden State Park. Segal and Granoff combined their efforts in 1998 with a nose defeat with Fit For Life. Now, they are looking for collective glory Saturday (July 17) with the likely post time favorite Perfect Sting in the 45th edition of the Meadowlands Pace.
- 2. Genealogy 101. Dale Frost sired Meadow Skipper who sired Most Happy Fella who sired Oil Burner who sired No Nukes who sired Western Hanover who sired Western Ideal who sired Always A Virgin who sired Always B Miki who sired both 2021 Pace starters Perfect Sting and Southwind Gendry the two morning line favorites.
- 3. Veterans Pace? The sires of the last three Pace winners were 18, 21 and 22 years old, respectively Art Major in 2018 and Bettors Delight in 2019 and 2020. Charlie May is a son of 22-year-old McArdle already a Pace-winning sire in 2010 with One More Laugh. American Courage is a son of 19-year-old American Ideal who was the sport's very first sub-148-winning sophomore in 2005 doing so at the Red Mile in 1:47.4.
- 4 Greatest Pace field top to bottom? I vote for 2012. A Rocknroll Dance gave Yannick Gingras his first Pace. Pet Rock was a world record holder when all was said and done. All Star Legend rocketed from the outside post early to just miss holding on for second. Fourth through 10th included: Sweet Lou, who earned over \$3.4 million lifetime and still owns the 5/8ths world record of 1:47; Bolt The Duer was a late finisher in the Pace who set the Adios world standard of 1:47.4 that year; Heston Blue Chip wound up the division winner with a 1:48 flat mark on the 5/8ths; Simply Business won the \$1,020,000 Metro the year before; State Treasurer went on to a fabulous career which included a season's best 1:47; Time



To Roll wound up nearing seven figures in earnings and has been a solid sire alongside brothers Tellitlikeitis and Rockin Image and Rockin Amadeus; Thinking Out Loud won the \$1,470,000 North America Cup and later a Breeders Crown.

- 5. David Miller is looking for Pace win #2. He was already in the Hall Of Fame when he won it with Courtly Choice in 2018. Linda Toscano's Hall of Fame acceptance speech came six days before she too broke through in the 2019 Pace with Best In Show. Perfect Sting's trainer Joe Holloway looks to follow that trend in 2021.
- 6. Very sweet 16 with Yannick Gingras and George Teague likely Hall of Fame bound in 2022 that means that now the last 16 Meadowlands Pace finals have been captured by either a Hall Of Fame driver, Hall of Fame trainer or both from 2005-2020. The record for any is 25-1959-1983 in the Hambletonian. Overall, 34 of 44 Pace finals have had a winning driver in the Hall and 12 of 44 a Hall of Fame conditioner.
- 7. Matt Kakaley will start American Courage from Post 10. Don't be too quick to dismiss. It was just three years ago that this very same thing happened and the longshot Dorsudoro Hanover took a tuck fifth, went first over and held dead game for second and wound up the division winner. Remember that both elims for the 2021 Meadowlands Pace were won by the outside post 7.
- 8. Charlie May, Chase H Hanover and Southwind Gendry are all geldings. Good history to look at here in the Pace. Geldings have held their own. Holborn Hanover at 58-1 in 2004 is the longest-priced winner. Gallo Blue Chip in 2000 went on to the single-season money record of over \$2.4 million greatly aided by the winner's share of \$1,150,000 (P B Bullville had supplemented for \$150,000 but did not get out of the elims). One More Laugh set the all-time 3YOGP mark of 1:47.4 in 2010 nipping Horse of the Year (HOY) Rock N Roll Heaven on the money. Wiggle It Jiggleit was HOY in 2015 and the last pacer to post a \$2 million season which included a Pace victory. Hot Lead in 1996 held on in the Pace and won the division title in George Brennan's Pace debut.
- 9. Die Laughing had back-to-back \$1 million seasons in 1990-1991 for the Val D'Or Farms. But the Pace was not a highlight. He finished last due to afib.
- 10. Tim Tetrick looks for Pace #6 with One Eight Hundred; Nancy Takter for her second straight. If this colt wins it would give the women three straight Pace wins as Linda Toscano upset in 2019 with Best In Show at 27-1.
- 11. Somebeachsomewhere edged Shadow Play in the 2008 Messenger. Thirteen years later their sons will go at it in the 45th edition of the Meadowlands Pace One Eight Hundred a son of 2008 HOY SBSW and Lawless Shadow a son of

- Shadow Play trained by Dr. Ian Moore, who also campaigned Shadow Play.
- 12. Abuckabett Hanover was sired by Betting Line, the 2016 sophomore pacing colt of the year and the first ever to have not competed at all at the Meadowlands during that award-winning season.
- 13. Brian Sears handles Chase H Hanover. Sears has won with the favorite (2005, Rocknroll Hanover) and a longshot (2019, Best In Show) along with Control The Moment in 2016.
- 14. Tony Alagna went 1-2 in the 2013 Meadowlands Pace and has two in this year —Abuckabett Hanover from post 8 and Rockyroad Hanover from post 6.
- 15. SBSW and Muscle Hill, despite their complete dominance on major race cards the past seven-eight years, have never sired a Horse of the Year neither one.
- 16. Home sweet home? Then box 1-9-10 homebreds Perfect Sting, Charlie May and American Courage.
- 17. Starters from the first crops of Betting Line and Always B Miki are represented in this year's Pace final. Captaintreacherous was the 2013 Pace winner from the first crop of SBSW.
- 18. Always B Miki and SBSW are the two Horse of the Year sires represented in the 2021 Meadowlands Pace field.
- 19. Mark MacDonald (Lawless Shadow) holds the unusual distinction of having the fastest mile of the year in harness racing 15 years apart. He did it first in 2005 with American Ideal and again in 2020 with Hurricane Emperor.

Finally...

Thirty-five years ago this week at the 1986 Meadowlands Pace press conference in Pegasus at the Meadowlands, Stan Bergstein announced that the harness racing world had just lost Billy Haughton at the age of 62. Though it was expected by then — his accident at Yonkers had occurred 12 days prior — nothing could prepare you for news like that.

We certainly could have benefitted from another 20-25 years from this man like no other. Just two years removed from yielding the drive on Nihilator in the richest race ever held, I always wonder how Billy would have handled the great filly/mare Peace Corps, who was born that year (1986). She was bred by Stanley Dancer and was a star for Haughton's son Tommy before heading overseas.

Billy was a presence with a capital P, and the last quarter of his life should have been spent telling us all about it — all the while still looking for that next champion.



Chris Beaver enjoys huge night

Conditioner looks to stay hot in Ohio Sire Stakes action this weekend.

On the Chinese calendar, 2021 is the year of the Ox, but in the state of Ohio this year looks to be the year of the Beaver - Chris Beaver.

The Radnor, OH-based trainer captured five of the eight \$40,000 Ohio Sire Stakes (OHSS) divisions of the 2-year-old trots last Friday (July 9) at Eldorado Scioto Downs and rounded out his evening with a sixth win in a \$17,000 conditioned trot.

His record night started early when his homebred **Caviar Gold** (Brett Miller) used a perfect pocket trip to score a 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ length win in 1:58.3 in the evening's first race.

The Triumphant Caviar colt is co-owned by Bill Manes, Leo Fleming and Steven Zeehandelar.

"I told Bret not to put him on the front because he was trying to pull up a little bit warming up. I put a Murphy (blind) on the outside," said Beaver. "This horse seems very talented. Brett said it was basically a training mile for him."

Stablemate Desperado Hall (Ronnie Wrenn, Jr.) was the pacesetter, but faded to third, beaten by two lengths.

The second win of the night was collected in the fifth race with **Gabbys C Note** (Brett Miller) by 5 ¾ lengths in 1:58.1.

Gabbys C Note came into the first OHSS leg off a pair of qualifying wins at the Delaware County Fairgrounds.

He was bred and co-owned by Chris' mother, Johanna Beaver, who shares ownership with her son and Zeehandelar.

"She's a really nice filly. It took a long time to get her gaited. She couldn't trot in 2:40 until April," said the 49-year-old trainer. "Once she got it figured out, she's become really determined and gritty."

The Beaver Stable was right back in the Eldorado Scioto Downs winner's circle in race #6 with **Caviar Roxie Due**.

Aaron Merriman guided the Triumphant Caviar-Rose Run Roxann filly to a neck score in 1:58.4.

Caviar Roxie Due was a \$14,000 yearling purchase at the Ohio Select Sale from the Dublin Valley Farm consignment. She is owned by Beaver, Zeehandelar, VIP Internet Stable and Tim Homan.

"She's one that I didn't think would make it through the middle of the winter," said Beaver. "She was real sore, but she's matured and got it all together and is good gaited now."

Despite winning three stakes races on the card, the bettors sent **Gabbys Bit Coin** off at odds of 15-1 in the seventh race.

Ronnie Wrenn, Jr. sat calmly behind the Uncle Peter gelding and sprinted past the favorite to win in 1:59.

"He's a real natural – trained well all along," said Beaver, who co-owns him with his mother, who bred.

Stephanie Hill (Aaron Merriman) made it four straight wins for Team Beaver in the eighth race.

The What The Hill lass nipped Be My Baby Now, who won the \$150,000 Next Generation event the week before, by a nose in 2:00.4.

"She's good mannered. I can't fault her in anyway. She's got lots of quick speed and was driven really well by Aaron."

She is owned in part by Moger-Delia Racing.

The memorable night wrapped up with a conditioned trot win by **Winning Ticket** (Aaron Merriman) in 1:56.1.

The sophomore gelded son of Triumphant Caviar is a perfect six-for-six on the season and has earned over \$205,000 career for Beaver. Zeehandelar. Homan and Jim Burnett.

"He's in good form right now," said Beaver. "They kind of handed him that race. No one really challenged him and he got easy fractions. It was a nice tightener. I have been a little leery to but him in with aged horses, but there is such a long gap between sire stakes legs, I had to get him in a real race."

Beaver finished the evening with a 6-1-1 record with 12 starters and took home \$127,300 in purses.

The Beaver Stable hopes to remain hot as they will take twelve horses to MGM Northfield Park Saturday night (July 17) for the second leg of the Ohio Sires Stakes for 2-year-old trotters and the third leg of the 3-year-old filly trot.

"I took one horse out of the sires stakes (You Zig I Zag – 9th place finish) and put one in."

The colt entering the OHSS action will be The Mighty Hill, who established a new MGM Northfield Park track standard for a gelded freshman trotter with his 1:56.3 victory in the \$17,500 Buckeye Stallion Series leg on July 5.

The What The Hill gelding, who was making his career debut, sat patiently early that night and took the lead pass the half mile station and used a last half in :57.1 to score the 2 1/2 length win.

"He was another horse that I thought got far behind the others because he was sore through a lot of the winter," said Beaver. "I thought he could win the Stallion Series, but was surprised how fast he went."

The Mighty Hill is owned by Beaver, Donald Robinson and the VIP Internet Stable.

Beaver's final entry on Northfield's Saturday night 16-race card will be the sophomore trotting mare, Ozma, in the \$60,000 OHSS leg.

Inaugural Ontario Women's Driving Championship on tap this weekend

"It's just fantastic to help raise the profile of women in the sport. Not just for women, to empower other girls and younger girls, but also for the men, to let them see that we can do this too," said Maggie Jones.


With less than 36 hours remaining before the first leg of the OLG Ontario Women's Driving Championship gets under way at Hanover Raceway, Maggie Jones and Julie Walker will be spending their spare time watching replays of their assigned horses and tamping down their excitement about the inaugural event.

"I was thrilled to be invited and I am really, really excited. I think it's going to be a really fun weekend and I am looking forward to it," said Jones. "I've looked at the entries, I've looked at the horse's lines, I'll probably watch some replays and I will be peppering the trainers with questions when we get there for sure. No one knows their horses better than the trainers so hopefully they can give me some good pointers."

Jones, who lives in Barrie, ON, teaches in the science department at Georgian College during the academic year and works alongside her husband Keith Jones through the summer, dedicating extra energy to her 10-year-old Muscle Mass gelding Mystery Bet. Jones drives — or rides, she and the gelding are qualified Racing Under Saddle (RUS) competitors — Mystery Bet in all of his races, but that has only amounted to four starts this year so she is really looking forward to climbing into a race bike in five straight races on both Saturday and Sunday. The second leg of the driving championship goes postward at Dresden Raceway on Sunday, July 18.

"To be in five races in one night, I think for most of the girls that doesn't happen," said Jones. "We might race once or twice

a week, so to be in five races in a night is going to be amazing. We're going to feel like real drivers."

Walker said shifting her mentality from that of a trainer to a driver is something she is focussing on heading into the event. The Owen Sound native is a full-time trainer based in Carlisle, ON who learned her trade alongside parents Paul and Brenda Walker and, like them, concentrates on developing trotters.

"Strategy-wise — we were talking about this (Wednesday) — I have to get the mentality of driving like a driver and not a trainer, so that's different for me," said Walker. "I always try to go in prepared. I'll watch some replays of the horses. Of course, when we're driving trotters, a lot of them I know, I watch them all the time. I don't watch a lot of pacing races, so now I have to do a little bit more homework, watching some replays and seeing what the horse is like.

"Me and Britt Kennedy were really hoping that we'd get at least one trotter race at Dresden or Hanover, but no, it looks like we're going to have all pacers. I don't mind. The last few years with the amateur races and then the women's driving thing they had up in Ottawa (in 2018) it was all pacers and it was actually kind of fun."

In addition to Jones and Walker, the Ontario Women's Driving Championship features Marie-Claude Auger of Trois-Rivieres, QC, Natasha Day of Cambridge, ON, Marielle Enberg of Guelph, ON, Pam Forgie of Goderich, ON, Britt Kennedy of Ingersoll, ON and Andrea Leon of Maidstone, ON.

While Jones and Walker do the bulk of their driving behind horses they own and train, Auger and Day ply their trade

full-time on the Ontario and Quebec circuits. Day is a regular at Hanover Raceway and the native of Australia expects that to work in her favour when the gate swings open Saturday.

"I know a lot of the horses, so that's going to be to my advantage, compared to like Marie who is coming down, she's not going to know a lot of those horses out there. She's driven at Hanover a few times, but it's different when you're driving there all the time," Day sald. "And I know how some of the girls drive, like Pam can be a very aggressive driver, same as Andrea, she can be very aggressive, and Marie, she's very aggressive, so you can kind of match up how these horses are going to be driven by the driver; who's going to be heading out early and who's going to be pulling first-over.

"Strategy is going to be a big thing for the weekend. You mightn't have the best horse in the race, but it's going to be all strategically played as far as how it will all turn out."

Win, lose or draw all three women are looking forward to the camaraderie of spending the weekend with their fellow drivers.

In addition to the points-based 10-race driving competition, which go postward as the first five races on Hanover Raceway's Saturday afternoon card (post time 1:30 pm) and the first five races on Dresden Raceway's Sunday afternoon card (post time 1 p.m.), the event is also a fundraiser for cervical and breast cancer.

On Saturday, the women will be donating their purse earnings to the Canadian Cancer Society for Cervical Cancer and Hanover Raceway is supplementing that effort with an online auction

(https://www.32auctions.com/Hanover2021 until July 17 at 6 pm). On Sunday, the fundraising will be dedicated to Harness The Hope, which dedicates its efforts to breast cancer awareness, research and support.

The driving championship was spearheaded by Hanover Raceway's general manager Steve Fitzsimmons. Fitzsimmons floated the idea at a Grassroots track symposium last fall and Dresden Raceway's Gary Patterson and Ontario Racing's Jonathan Zammit were quick to get on board as co-hosts and sponsors. Fitzsimmons then approached the OLG, who signed on as the title sponsor of the two-day event.

For her part, Walker is grateful to the team at what she still considers her hometown track for their efforts to create a unique event to both showcase Ontario's female drivers and raise awareness about cervical and breast cancer.

"I was definitely excited for Hanover Raceway to be able to put on an event like that, for going above and beyond when it comes to horse racing. It's nice to see, during the pandemic and everything that's been going on, that there are some different events going to happen and to be a part of it, it's nice," said Walker. "And in this case of course we're bringing awareness to cancer as well, which for some people hits home a lot harder than other people."

Ramona Hill leads dozen trotters into Hambletonian Maturity

A little more than a year ago, Ramona Hill became the fourth female trotter to win the Hambletonian Stakes since it moved to The Meadowlands Racetrack in 1981. On Saturday, she will return to The Big M to try to add the E.T. Gerry Jr. Hambletonian Maturity to her list of accomplishments.

Since the modern version of the Hambletonian Maturity was created in 2014, only one horse has won both races — Marion Marauder. Ramona Hill will face 11 rivals in Saturday's edition, leaving from post four with driver Andy McCarthy at the lines for trainer Tony Alagna. The event, for 4-year-old trotters, will be contested at 1-1/8 miles.

The Hambletonian Maturity is part of a stakes-filled card that includes the \$700,000 Meadowlands Pace for 3-year-old pacers. Racing begins at a special time, 6 p.m. (EDT), and the Maturity and Pace will be part of a two-hour broadcast on Fox Sports 2 starting at 8 p.m.

Ramona Hill enters the Hambletonian Maturity with a second-place finish among two races this season. She went off stride in her most recent start, the Joie De Vie Stakes on July 3, which was on a track labeled "good" at The Meadowlands.

"The night she made a break behind the gate, the track was a little sticky and Andy wanted to let her trot out of there a little bit and she just got tangled up," Alagna said.

Since then, Ramona Hill qualified with hobbles, winning in 1:53.1 at The Meadowlands.

"We decided to qualify her to get a good mile into her," Alagna said. "She's always had some issues with her back, so we put the hobbles on her trying to help her out a little bit. She qualified good and she trained good (Wednesday) morning, so hopefully she's on the right track. I was very happy with how she trained this morning."

A Dan Patch Award recipient at ages 2 and 3, Ramona Hill has won 12 of 19 races, hit the board an additional four times, and earned \$1.33 million. The daughter of Muscle Hill—Lock Down Lindy is owned by Brad Grant, Crawford Farms Racing, Robert LeBlanc, and In The Gym Partners. She was bred by Crawford Farms.

Ramona Hill's Meadowlands magic last season included a win from post 10 in the Del Miller Memorial, which served as a precursor to memorable performances in her Hambletonian elimination, when she rallied from eighth place at three-quarters to win by a half-length, and in the Hambletonian final, which she captured in a stakes-record-equaling 1:50.1.

"We hope that she can regain that form because everybody knows when she's on her game there are not many who can go with her," Alagna said. "We're just trying to get her back to that point. Hopefully, she will show that Saturday night."

The competition Saturday night includes Nancy Takter-trained Ready For Moni, who finished second in the Hambletonian and comes into the Maturity off a 1:50.3 triumph in last week's Graduate Series Trot final for 4-year-olds.

Ready For Moni has won two of four races this season and 11 of 23 lifetime. The win in the Graduate pushed his career earnings over \$1 million.

"He's raced super every start this year," Takter said after the Graduate final. "He's been closing really well. It's tough sometimes for 4-year-olds to make the adjustments for their 4-year-old year, especially when they've had long 3-year-old seasons. He seems to be handling it pretty well and I look forward to racing him the rest of the year."

Takter also sends last year's Hambletonian Oaks winner, Sorella, into the Hambletonian Maturity. She is one of five mares in the race.

Dancer Memorial contenders set to make case for Hambletonian

Thirteen 3-year-old male trotters have been divided into a pair of divisions in Saturday night's (July 17) \$273,500 Stanley Dancer Memorial Trot at The Meadowlands, with a dozen eligible to the upcoming Hambletonian, which has eliminations on Aug. 1 and the \$1 million final on Aug. 8.

The Dancer is one of several stakes on a star-studded program that is highlighted by the \$700,000 Meadowlands Pace. More information on the entire card can be found here.

The baker's dozen going to post in the two Dancer splits does not include recent Yonkers Trot champion Johan Palema, who was not eligible and was entered instead by trainer Ake Svanstedt into an overnight that will be contested on Friday night (July 16) at the Big M.

Yannick Gingras drove Johan Palema to his gate-to-wire victory in the Yonkers Trot, and in the Dancer divisions he will guide for the first time the Svanstedt-trained Captain Corey from post two in the \$138,000 second split (race 11).

Svanstedt has driven Captain Corey in all nine of the son of Googoo Gaagaa's career starts, with last year's five triumphs including a pair of track records as well as the \$253,000 Pennsylvania Sires Stakes championship.

Captain Corey returned in 2021 with a Pennsylvania Sires Stakes (PASS) victory on May 31 at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono, but then the colt made a break at the start of a PASS event on June 23 at Harrah's Philadelphia. Captain Corey then romped to an 8-1/2 length, career-best 1:53 win in a July 10 qualifier at The Meadowlands.

"We'll see how he is this week," said Gingras. "We talked a little bit about (me driving Captain Corey) last year because Ake had a couple nice ones, but it just never worked out. Ake asked me this week if I would go with him in this race. We'll go one race at a time, but I'm definitely really excited about driving him.

"He hasn't raced in almost a month now because he made a break and then had a qualifier, so I don't think he's primed and ready to rock and roll, probably, but I'll try and trip him out and see what happens."

The colt is owned by S R F Stable, Knutsson Trotting, Midnight Sun Partners and Ake Svanstedt Inc.

Starting immediately to Gingras and Captain Corey's right on the gate in post three is the reigning Dan Patch divisional champ Venerate, who made a break in the last turn in his sophomore debut in a June 26 overnight against older horses at The Meadowlands. Venerate shrugged that off quickly as he



rebounded in a big way with a 1:52.1 win over a "sloppy" track in the Reynolds at the Big M on July 10.

"In his first start it was just one of those things where he got a little mixed up and made a break, but he bounced back pretty strong," said Andy Miller, who drives the Love You colt he shares ownership of with Pinske Stables. "He raced super last week and I was real happy with him."

In his Reynolds score, Venerate started from post nine and was parked the entire mile. Still, he had enough left to trot a final quarter of :26.3 to get the half-length victory over Sonofamistery, who made a break nearing the wire but appeared to be beaten anyways.

"It was a big trip and he was out a long ways, but he kept on marching," said Miller of the Julie Miller-trained colt. "Hopefully he doesn't have to go parked the whole mile again, but I think he's headed in the right direction.

"I'm sure he'll be out part of the mile but hopefully not the whole mile."

Also in that Dancer division is On A Streak, who is owned by Serge Godin's Determination and trained by Luc Blais, the same connections who won the 2019 Hambletonian with Forbidden Trade. Starting from post four with driver Daniel Dube, the son of Cantab Hall won just twice last year in 10 starts, but they came in the \$600,000 Breeders Crown final at Harrah's Hoosier Park and the \$406,600 William Wellwood Memorial at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

This year, On A Streak has already equaled his win output of 2020 in just five starts, those coming in a Pennsylvania Stallion event at Pocono and an overnight at Yonkers. After finishing fourth in his Yonkers Trot elimination, On A Streak finished sixth in the final after making an early break on the "sloppy" track.

"He never made a break before and something happened, and it was a good thing he didn't hurt himself," noted Blais, who uprooted most of his Ontario-based stable this year due to COVID-19 travel restrictions and found a home at White Birch Farm in New Jersey. "I trained him (Wednesday) morning and he was good. I just don't know what happened last time, maybe he just took a bad step. He's sound and I think he will be all right this weekend. He's in a tough division but it's a good test to see where we are."

That same division also includes Cuatro De Julio, whose 1:51.3 victory last year at The Red Mile was the second fastest by a freshman trotter. A nine-time winner in 14 starts last year, Cuatro De Julio has a win and two seconds in three New Jersey Sires Stakes contests this year, with one of those seconds coming in

the \$200,000 final. Following that race, Cuatro De Julio coasted to an open-lengths qualifier win on June 30 at The Red Mile.

Known for his high speed but also being a bit high strung, Cuatro De Julio will see an equipment change as Marie Ortolan Bar, who trains the son of Trixton for owner D Farm, said she will be adding ear plugs. Adding the ear plugs while training has helped Cuatro De Julio. "For the first time he is super quiet," said the conditioner. Lucas Wallin will drive Cuatro De Julio from post five.

As if that division isn't strong enough on paper, the field also includes the aforementioned Sonofamistery, with the son of Muscle Hill starting from the outside post seven. The late miscue in the Reynolds was the second consecutive start Sonofamistery suffered the same fate, but on June 25 in a Big M overnight, it cost him a win as he was first across the wire but disqualified to second. Prior to that he won a 3-year-old open at The Meadowlands in 1:51.2, the fastest mile by a sophomore colt trotter thus far in 2021.

"He's a nice horse, a fast horse, but we still have some problems with him as he's made two breaks right at the wire," Melander said of the colt owned by S R F Stable and Holly Lane Stud East Ltd. "He's running down a little bit on us and I'll change some of his shoeing. If he stays flat all the way to the wire, he's a contender. He's a very fast horse and as good as anyone else. Hopefully we can figure him out and he'll be a contender."

Melander will start Dancinginthedark M in the \$135,500 first Dancer division (race two), with the Readly Express colt owned by Menhammar Stuteri Ab starting from post one with driver Tim Tetrick.

That division also includes from post six the Andy McCarthydriven, Mark Harder-trained Zenith Stride, who sprung an 87-1 upset in last year's \$319,000 Peter Haughton Memorial at The Meadowlands.

Dancinginthedark M won three of seven starts last year, and he cruised to victories in his first two attempts this year. His third start in a June 26 overnight at The Meadowlands didn't go as well as he made a break behind the gate when starting from the outside post 10.


"It was no fun when he made the break but I wasn't worried," said Melander. "He had some bad habits last year when he got too grabby, but I wasn't worried at all that night."

Melander's faith was justified in the second Reynolds division on July 10 when his pupil brushed to the front past the opening quarter and never looked back en route to a 1:51.4 score over the "sloppy" surface.

"That was a hell of a mile, especially with the weather," said Melander.



Clare MacDonald records 1,500th driving win

Clare MacDonald started 2021 just two driving wins away from the 1,500 mark. Once the Atlantic Sires Stakes got rolling, it didn't take her long to make up the difference: North America's top active female driver sent 3-year-old trotter Mr Finlay Ridge to an early lead in his division Tuesday night (July 13) at Truro Raceway and they never looked back, winning by more than three open lengths.

The gelding's second consecutive ATSS victory was a memorable one for MacDonald, who trains and shares ownership of Mr Finlay Ridge with breeder Arnold Rankin and Ian Tate. The Armbro Barrister—R Rocket Rachel (by Angus Hall) son took a new personal best of 2:00.1h in the winning effort. Mr Finlay Ridge's full brother, Mabou Ridge, holds Truro Raceway's record for 2-year-old trotters (2:00.0h), also set in rein to trainer/driver MacDonald, in 2019.

Trotters have marked some important moments in MacDonald's driving career: Her 1,000th driving win was with homebred West River Redwing at Summerside Raceway in 2007. In 1994, she was in the sulky behind the first Maritimebred trotter to break the 2:00 barrier on a Maritime track: West River Exotic raised the bar with his 1:59.4h Atlantic Sires Stakes victory at Exhibition Park Raceway, which still stands today as the New Brunswick half-mile oval's fastest-ever trot mile. MacDonald drove the first Maritime-bred female trotter to break the 2:00 barrier on a Maritime track: Dunmore Skye's 1:59.4h record still stands as the fastest ever for her age and gait at Truro Raceway. It was set in a 1997 Atlantic Sires Stakes Three-Year-Old Trot.

Among female North American drivers, only the late Bea Farber has more driving wins (1,801) than the Maritime-based MacDonald, who was short-listed for the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame ballot this year.

Mr Finlay Ridge delivered both of the victories needed for the Antigonish, NS horsewoman to reach the 1,500 mark. When interviewed before the start of the 2021 Maritime racing season, MacDonald indicated that the most important win is always the next one: "They'll come when they come, the same

as the first 1,498 came. It's not a milestone I'm trying to get and then hang it up. They're just points along the way. Take tomorrow as it comes."

Meadowlands policy on 2021 Breeders Crown entries

This is a slight departure from the language in the conditions for all stakes administered by The Meadowlands. The standard requirement is that horses in stakes races be in the stable of an approved trainer by May 15. The purpose of this modification is to afford accepted owners the opportunity to place their 2021 Breeders Crown eligible horses with a trainer that will be able to race them.

This does not include, and The Meadowlands reserves the right to reject the entry of, any horse whose ownership is excluded from participation at The Meadowlands.

Novice trotting fillies sharp in OSS Grassroots debut

The novice trotting fillies made winning look easy in a trio of \$22,850 Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Grassroots divisions at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Tuesday (July 13).

Angelonia opened the OSS event with an effortless front-end score from Post 5. The fan favorite and driver Tyler Moore rolled through fractions of :29, 1:00 and 1:29, repelling a challenge from Tijuana Seelster on their way to a one and one-half length victory in 1:58.3. Classic Magic got up for second and Tijuana Seelster settled for third. (**replay here: Angelonia**).

Moore drives Angelonia for his father, Dr. Ian Moore of Cambridge, ON and Frank Cannon of Sanford, FL, who purchased the daughter of Archangel from last fall's London Virtual Yearling Sale for \$52,400.

"I always look at a few trotters every year and I've tried to prod a few partners along to get one, but nobody ever wants one," said Dr. Moore. "So this year Frank Cannon, who is the primary owner on Tattoo Artist, said, 'Let's get a trotter Doc.' I said, 'I'm in, no problem'. So I went looking and I looked at her at Tara Hills and I liked her, and Frank liked her breeding, and

so we said we'd go \$50,000. She's been a little bit of fun."

After a pair of qualifiers in mid-June the partners were aiming Angelonia at the July 6 Gold Series, but a minor foot problem required a shoeing adjustment and slowed the filly's arrival on the provincial stakes scene.

"I said, 'I think I'll just take my time with her,' so I didn't put her in it, but that's what our original plan was," said Dr. Moore, adding that a step up to the Gold might be in the filly's future. "That's the fastest she's been by three seconds and it's been three or four weeks since she went in 2:01.2 (June 24), so I thought it was pretty good myself. She's probably better from behind, she gets pretty lackadaisical on the front end; even training she's like that. I know they (Golds) went a little faster, I looked at them the other night, but we still probably will (try Gold)."

Plan A for **Mischevious Rose** might also have been the Gold Series, but a bout of sickness caused trainer Johnathan McKinnon to press pause on her schedule. The Muscle Mass daughter made her debut in the second division and after sitting comfortably in fourth as Clockwork Orange rang up fractions of :29.2, :59.4 and 1:29.3 she stepped out in the stretch and laid down an impressive :27.2 last quarter to claim a three-quarter length victory in 1:58. Clockwork Orange settled for second behind the favorite while Cleveland Moneyka was well behind the leaders in third. (**replay here: Mischevious Rose**).

"She's a great filly. I've never sat behind her, but I've seen her all winter and all spring, she was the best trotting filly we had really," said driver Mario Baillargeon, who guided the filly from Post 4. "She got sick a little bit so Johnny (McKinnon) took his time with her and she was impressive tonight, :27.2 on the end there and first lifetime start, you don't see too many two-year-old trotting fillies do that.

"I don't know if she's a Gold yet, but if she improves a little more she probably will be a Gold filly," said Baillargeon. "She's just the right size, she'll trot any track, and she trots so smooth and has got a real high speed."

Baillargeon of Acton and McKinnon of Guelph drive and train Mischevious Rose for fractional ownership group **TheStable**. ca. Mischevious Rose of Guelph, ON, and several of her owners were on hand to celebrate the filly's first lifetime win.

The final Grassroots blanket went home with favorite **Da Royal Miracle**, who took command before the half and fought off a challenge from Lilys Lass in the stretch to secure a head victory in 2:00. Trade Secret finished five lengths behind the duelling leaders in third. (**replay here: Da Royal Miracle**)

Chris Christoforou drives Da Royal Miracle for trainer Laurie Bako of Aylmer and his co-owners Roy Knight of Port Stanley, Rickey Moffatt of Dorchester and Robert Woodburn of St. Thomas, ON. The win was the Royalty For Life daughter's second, she was also a winner in a two-year-old filly overnight event at Woodbine Mohawk Park on July 1.

Bateson has been involved with standardbred horses since 1981 and bought part of his first racehorse in 1986. He currently owns several racehorses and broodmares residing in Ohio.

A director of the Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association since 2011, Bateson served as vice president of the organization for four years and is its current president, a position he has held since 2019. In his role at the OHHA, Bateson helped implement the Buckeye Stallion Series for 2- and 3-year-olds, which added another valuable classification for staking many outstanding Ohio-bred foals.

A graduate of The Ohio State University with a Bachelor of Science degree in Agricultural Economics, Bateson has worked for 30 years in sales for both manufacturing and distribution in the agricultural chemistry industry. He is currently a strategic account sales manager for Rosen's Inc.

Bateson and his wife Terri have three sons — Case, Garret and Levi. Case, their oldest, has also begun a career in the standardbred industry.
