# Lawless Shadow elevated to Meadowlands Pace victory

It was an all-Canadian triumph as the Ontario-sired colt produced by Seelster Farms was declared the winner after Charlie May was disqualified for interference.

Dr. Ian Moore's first Meadowlands Pace win came in a way he never experienced victory before in a major stakes – by disqualification.

**Lawless Shadow** was declared the winner of Saturday's (July 17) \$700,000 Meadowlands Pace for 3-year-old pacers after Charlie May was disqualified for causing interference coming out of the final turn at the Meadowlands Racetrack.

Charlie May was first across the finish line, a neck ahead of Lawless Shadow, over a "good" surface in 1:48.3 in the rain at the Big M. But Charlie May was placed ninth for interfering with Rockyroad Hanover and Abuckabett Hanover as he came three-wide heading into the stretch.

Lawless Shadow was elevated to first, with favorite Perfect Sting second and Southwind Gendry third.

It was the first Meadowlands Pace win for Moore and driver

"I never won a big race on a setback before, but I guess we'll take it," said Moore, a native of Prince Edward Island that is based in Ontario.

"He's a real nice colt. I prepped him for this all along. We were

hoping to come here and I'm glad we did now, for sure, even in the pouring rain."

Lawless Shadow led the field to the first quarter in :25.3 before Perfect Sting took command on his way to a :53.2 half. On the backstretch, One Eight Hundred, who was second at the quarter-mile point, went off stride because of broken equipment.

Charlie May followed the cover of first-over Southwind Gendry as the group raced to three quarters in 1:21.3. Lawless Shadow was third in the stretch and battled with Charlie May and Perfect Sting to the wire.

"I kind of feel bad for (Charlie May's driver, Brett Miller); he's a good friend of mine," said MacDonald, who is also a native of Prince Edward Island. "It was just a bad situation there. But I think if my horse gets out a little sooner, I might have won anyway. It's still a win, but you hate to kind of win like that."

Sent off at 5-1, Lawless Shadow paid \$12.40.

Lawless Shadow finished second by a neck to Southwind Gendry in last week's Meadowlands Pace eliminations.

"We came to race," MacDonald said. "Ian told me the first week, we brought him here to race, (so) let's put him in play. So, that's what I did."

Lawless Shadow, who caused a delay to the start of the Pace when he returned to the paddock for a shoe repair, won for the fourth time in seven races this year and eighth time in 16 career starts.

The colt has earned more than \$620,000 for owners Moore, R G McGroup Ltd., Frank Cannon, and former Montréal Canadiens star Serge Savard, a winner of 10 Stanley Cups (eight as a player and two as general manager of the Canadiens). Lawless Shadow was bred by Seelster Farms of Lucan, ON and was the 2020 O'Brien Award winner as Canada's best 2-year-old male pacer. Prior to the Meadowlands Pace eliminations, Lawless Shadow

"All his races prior to the weekend before we came here were with aged horses; he did very well, as we expected," Moore said. "I was a little disappointed with his last start in Ontario, but he got beat by a really good colt up there, Bulldog Hanover.

"There's another (OSS) Gold next weekend, so we'll see how he comes out of this and go from there."

Total handle for the 14-race program was \$4,503,213, marking the second occurrence of Meadowlands Pace Night handle eclipsing the \$4.5-million mark in the past 13 years. Bettors

**Donna Soprano** and **You Ato Dream** strengthened their credentials as legitimate Hambletonian Oaks contenders with victories in their respective divisions of the \$281,500 Delvin Miller Memorial for 3-year-old trotting fillies on Saturday (July 17) at The Meadowlands.

You Ato Dream (Jeff Gregory) captured the second division of the Del Miller Memorial at The Meadowlands in 1:52.2.

Hanover—Windsong Soprano filly quickly reached the favorite by the 1:24 three-quarters, and a good battle down the stretch saw Donna Soprano, the 3-1 second choice, wear down Beltassima by a half-length in 1:51.3, a lifetime best. May Karp, not quick to clear, was another half-length back at 75-1.

Daniel Dubé, who drove Donna Soprano for trainer Luc Blais and owner Determination, said that, "I saw others leaving, so I was in no hurry to go forward." Asked about the difficulty of the first-over trip, Dubé said, "I thought she was the best, and as soon as I kicked the earplugs, she responded and she went on by."

Donna Sopranao was bred by White Birch Farm and purchased for \$190,000 at the 2019 Standardbred Horse Sales Company yearling auction in Harrisburg, PA.

In the \$139,500 second division (race three), 2020 Breeders Crown winner Lady Chaos, the 6-5 favorite, went out to command and slowed the quarter to :28. You Ato Dream, the 5-2 second choice away third for trainer/driver Jeff Gregory, thought it an opportune time to move to the lead, and, after making the top, put up soft middle fractions of :56.4 and 1:25. "When I saw the three-quarters time," said George Romanoff, who shares ownership with Jeff Gregory Inc., William Richardson and Martin Garey, "I was feeling very comfortable."

Lady Chaos did her best to try to dissipate that comfort, but after clearing relatively late, she could only get within a diminishing half-length of the winner at the end of the 1:52.2 mile — also a lifetime mark. Hot As Hill finished only another neck back in third after a troubled trip. You Ato Dream has now won four of seven starts this year after only winning once and finishing second seven times in 10 starts as a rookie.

You Ato Dream was bred by M. Biasuzzi Stable Inc. and purchased for \$45,000 at the 2019 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale.

#### Indiana's Hot Mess Express resolute in Mistletoe Shalee

While it may not have been a slam dunk, **Hot Mess Express** proved resolute under pressure to record a 1:48.3 win in the \$174,400 Mistletoe Shalee for 3-year-old pacing fillies on Saturday (July 17) at The Meadowlands.

Blue Diamond Eyes took the early lead followed by Grace Hill and Hot Mess Express, who briefly settled in third before driver Andy McCarthy angled her out to take the lead and cut an opening quarter of :27.1.


Once in control, Hot Mess Express coasted to a :54.2 half, still chased by Blue Diamond Eyes and Grace Hill. Racing into the second turn, Dexter Dunn took to the outside from fourth with

Fire Start Hanover to swiftly challenge the leader to three-quarters in 1:21.4. Fire Start Hanover was game, making Hot Mess Express work in deep stretch to take the mile by three-quarters of a length. Blue Diamond Eyes finished third, another 2-1/4 lengths behind.

Tony Alagna trains Hot Mess Express for owner and former NBA player Sam Bowie. She is now a perfect six-for-six this season after winning her last four starts at Harrah's Hoosier Park, including the Nadia Lobell on July 4.

"As far as this filly is concerned," McCarthy said, "she was a dream filly. And to see what she did tonight was absolutely incredible. She can win on the front; she can come from off the pace ... but the thing I like tonight is [that] she put a step or two in and she was able to gather herself and go a mile in [1:]48 and a piece."

Hot Mess Express, a daughter of Panther Hanover out of My Heart Was True, increased her earnings to \$401,655 with the Mistletoe Shalee victory. She paid \$2.40 to win.

Three-time Breeders Crown winner Manchego (Dexter Dunn) bounced back from a narrow defeat in the Crawford Farms Trot to capture Saturday's Miss Versatility over 10 distaff trotting rivals in a track record 1:49.4 at The Meadowlands.

# Manchego equals Big M track record in Miss Versatility


As soon as driver Dexter Dunn got on the track with **Manchego** for Saturday's (July 17) \$40,000 fourth leg of the Miss Versatility Series for trotting mares at The Meadowlands, he had a good feeling. Dunn's initial impression proved correct.

Manchego equaled the Meadowlands track record for an older female trotter with a 1:49.4 triumph — the first sub-1:50 trotting mile of the season — defeating Weslynn Quest by 1-1/2 lengths. When Dovescry finished third and Atlanta was a late-charging fourth.

The time matched the divisional standard set by Darling Mearas S in 2019.

"Honestly, I don't think she's felt any better post parading than tonight," Dunn said. "As soon as she got on the track, she just felt so good. She loved it out there."

Weslynn Quest took the early lead, getting the field to the first quarter in :27.4, but Manchego came calling on the backstretch and was on top in a :55 half. It was the first time Manchego was in front at the half in eight starts dating back to last October.



From there, it was all Manchego. She reached three quarters in 1:23 and cruised to victory for trainer Nancy Takter and owner Black Horse Racing.

"She hasn't been on the front in a while, but she had her ears perked up and got along good," Dunn said. "She was still traveling good [in the stretch]. I've driven her enough to know how she feels, and if someone was going to go past her, they'd have to be pretty good."

Manchego has won four of five races this year and 37 of 61 lifetime. She has earned \$2.89 million.

The 6-year-old daughter of Muscle Hill and Secret Magic was bred by Brittany Farms. She was a Dan Patch Award winner at ages 2 and 5.

"She's better than she was last year," Dunn said. "She's just so happy right now. Her gait has always been great, but it's even better."

Sent off as the 8-5 second choice behind favorite Atlanta, Manchego paid \$5.20 to win.

## JK First Lady shatters records in Dorothy Haughton

The promised rain started to fall just before Saturday's (July 17) \$178,500 Dorothy Haughton Memorial for pacing mares at The Meadowlands, but the impeccably-bred **JK First Lady** (\$6.60) didn't let the weather bother her at all, as she benefited from a perfect Dexter Dunn drive to break the world record for 4-year-old pacing mares by way of a 1:47.4 clocking.

Dunn hustled the homebred daughter of Western Ideal out of former Horse of the Year JK She'salady away from the gate from post six in the bulky field of 11, making the lead before yielding to the streaking Rocknificent at the completion of a :25.4 quarter. JK First Lady sat in the pocket through middle fractions of :53.3 and 1:21.

Trainer Nancy Takter said, "She's got a great turn of foot after following a helmet, so into the stretch, I kept rooting, 'Sit with her, Dexter, sit with her!' and then Dexter moved her at just the right time."

Getting out in time and into gear quickly, JK First Lady went by 17-1 pacesetter Rocknificent to win by three-quarters of a length while eclipsing both the previous divisional world record of 1:48, set two weeks ago by Lyons Sentinel, and the previous stakes record of 1:48.1, set in 2020 by Major Occasion A.

Lyons Sentinel, who was the 9-5 favorite despite starting from post 10, couldn't find a forward early position and had to follow deep cover, swung five-wide turning for home and was flying late, just missing getting third ahead of the ground-saving Peaky Sneaky. JK First Lady was the 2-1 second choice; the other 2-1 choice, Gia's Surreal, faded after a failed first-over bid.

The victory was the first of the year for JK First Lady, but she has earned \$851,990 in her career, during which she has consistently been among the leaders of her division.

"She really is a family horse," Nancy Takter said, and indeed the 3 Brothers Stable own not only her but also her dam, JK She'salady.

The victory was the second in a row in this event for two-time defending Driver of the Year Dexter Dunn. Nancy Takter had never sent out a winner in this event, but her father, Hall of Famer Jimmy Takter, did in 2007 with Armbro Dancer.







The pair squabbled into the final turn while Sonofamistery lost ground to three-quarters in 1:23.1. But as the dueling duo grew leg weary in the straightaway, Sears fanned Sonofamistery off the pegs and soared to a 1-1/4-length victory over Captain Corey, with Cuatro De Julio finishing third and Rattle My Cage fourth.

# Is Grand River's plan to expand to a 5/8ths spoiling Dr. Ted Clarke's vision?

Not exactly. In fact, the late Hall of Famer planned for the possibility all along.

Those that knew the man most responsible for building Grand River Raceway in Elora, ON likely knew the late Hall of Famer Dr. Ted Clarke was particularly passionate about making it a half-mile track despite the track being built just 19 years ago in a time when smaller tracks were already considered passé. What people might not know is that despite deciding against constructing a five-eighths mile track in the first place, Clarke was enough of a visionary to not only draw up plans for the larger oval, but also have other contingency plans for the possibility of future expansion.

Early in the track's existence, Grand River sold off a piece of land to a prominent Canadian grocery store chain, but "actually saved a little carve out of that property to allow for the five-eighths track designed by Ted," said Jamie Martin, who succeeded Clarke as the track's director of operations.

Now Martin is moving forward with a plan to expand Grand River to a five-eighths.

We've dusted it off... and what we're doing this year is going through the due diligence of making sure it works and getting approved by the municipality. It shouldn't be an issue... we do have Ontario Racing and OLG (Ontario Lottery and Gaming) fund support for the project," Martin said of the construction estimated to cost \$2 million and be completed in time for the start of the 2023 season.

"I'm pretty sure we're going to do it, but there could be a hiccup that we don't anticipate," Martin said. "I'm pretty sure we'll finish the planning process probably by October and have everything approved by then, from a municipal construction aspect. There's always been water issues up here and so forth... We would construct next year, so we would be able to open in 2023. We couldn't do much over the winter, I don't think, so we couldn't get ready for opening in May of next year. The main stretch would be the only piece that would be consistent between the two tracks and so we could tie that together after next year's racing."

Martin said expanding the track would simply be better both for horses and for driving handle by putting more post positions in play for bettors.

"(Clarke) may have not wanted to put in a five-eighths, and I think we know he didn't, but he did account for it one day," Martin said. "I don't know if he'd do it today, but... for me, Ontario Racing and OLG are making lots of infrastructure investments in tracks. I'm not sure too many of them have the potential to generate more revenue, but this one does.

"Every track has made improvements because of the \$6 million a year that goes to all the tracks except for Woodbine and Mohawk. We've all taken advantage of it. Most tracks have new

(717) 637-8931 fax: (717) 637-6766 theblackbook.com starting gates. (High definition) video equipment is a good example... A lot of those investments went to fixing roofs and things like that, and that's important, too, but that doesn't really generate any additional revenue for the industry."

Clarke's chief arguments for making it a half-mile track in the first place was that it better served the grassroots side of the industry both by allowing fans to get close to the horses and by dissuading larger stables from coming to race for money designed to go to smaller stables.

But Martin said a half-mile track also dissuades many stables from racing at Grand River and puts too many outside post positions out of considering for bettors.

"I do think half-mile track racing is from another time. There's going to be lots of halves still around, but I think if we have the chance to put in a bigger track, we should. So, we're pursuing it," Martin said.

Besides, Martin points out that the track's leading trainer in 2020 was eight-time Canadian Trainer of the Year Richard Moreau. The fact Grand River has a half-mile oval isn't dissuading the bigger operations from racing there any longer.

Meaning Dr. Ted Clarke likely isn't rolling over in his grave and would most likely approve.

#### MGM Springfield Stakes final won by Pleaseletmeknow

**Pleaseletmeknow** gave driver Matt Kakaley, trainer Travis Alexander, and owner/breeder Fiddler's Creek Stables LLC. their second significant stakes victory of the month at Yonkers Raceway by taking Friday night's (July 16) \$150,000 MGM Springfield Stakes final for 2-year-old male pacers in 1:54.3.

A stablemate to MGM Grand Messenger Stakes champion American Courage, Pleaseletmeknow showed early speed from post seven and was able to tuck into the third position while Silverstone (George Brennan) blasted to the lead and carved out opening-half fractions of :27.2 and :56.1.

Kakaley had Pleaseletmeknow out and on the move first-over as the rookies raced towards the 1:25 three-quarters, with Thebiznes Bluechip (Jordan Stratton) picking up the cover to sit second-over. Pleaseletmeknow would move up to engage

Silverstone on the last turn, with Thebiznes Bluechip firing three-wide, and by the time they turned for home, Pleaseletmeknow had taken over the top spot.

Through the lane Pleaseletmeknow responded when called upon by Kakaley, and he was able to keep Thebiznes Bluechip at bay to win by a length. Letmecallyouback (Joe Bongiorno) advanced from fifth to third in the last quarter, Gone Before Dawn (Austin Siegelman) checked in fourth from off-the-pace, and Silverstone had to settle for fifth after putting up the fractions.

"It was a big effort from the seven-hole. He's learning but is a professional," said Alexander. "It's nice to win these races but extra special with a homebred. We bought his mother at the Lexington sale the same day as American Courage's dam with the intentions of having their foals. It's nice when a plan works out."

Coming up next for Pleaseletmeknow will be the New York Sire Stakes at Saratoga on July 24, and he will remain in the Empire State after that, as well.

"He doesn't have anything this year outside of New York," Alexander said. "He was behind, so we staked him lightly."

A gelded son of American Ideal—I Said Please (Well Said), Pleaseletmeknow has a record of 2-1-0 from three career starts, and this win pushed his bankroll to \$95,900. The 8-5 favorite, Pleaseletmeknow paid \$5.40 to win and was atop an \$18.80 exacta and a \$59.00 trifecta.

#### Takter dominates Breakfast With The Babies – Meadowlands Pace edition

Breakfast With The Babies, Meadowlands Pace Day edition, sponsored by Fashion Farms, was held Saturday morning under muggy conditions and cloudy skies absent of wind. There were a few qualifiers of note after the babies were completed.

It turned out to be Nancy Takter day at BWTB as the 2020 Dan Patch Trainer Of The Year won six of the nine baby races and a qualifier on the morning.

Takter's New Jersey Sires Stakes (NJSS) final winning sophomore trotting colt **Really Fast** held off the charge of Kildare King in 1:51.2 for Yannick Gingras.

Top open class pacer **Nicholas Beach** reeled off what, to the knowledge of the panel of experts present, the fastest qualifying race ever. Driver Joe Bongiorno put Nick on the front through a half in :55, set sail with a :27.2 third panel then flew home in :25.2 for a 1:47.4 final time with Bongiorno sitting chilly in the bike.

Crawford Trot winner of a few weeks ago **Forbidden Trade** (Dan Dube) just got up over Mississippi Storm in 1:51.2 to wrap up the day.

An American Ideal colt match race opened the card when the first was scratched down to two. Scott Zeron put **Go With The Flow** on the lead from the start and held sway over Third Power (Dexter Dunn) despite drifting noticeably in the stretch, the mile in 1:55. Go With The Flow is trained by Linda Toscano for owner/breeder Arnie Chusid.

Jimmy Takter drove the Father Patrick colt **Takato** to a 1:57.3 win over stablemate Pretender (Josert Fonseca) in race 2.

Nancy Takter trains the winner for Black Horse Racing, John Fielding and her mom Christina who paid \$140,000 for the colt in Lexington from breeder Steve Stewart and Kemppi Farms.

JK Standingovation (Dunn) won right back for Nancy in the third, stalking an honest pace set by El Pistolero (Andy Miller) and breaking the beam in 1:53.4 / :28.1. The son of JK Endofanera cost 3 Brothers Stables and Caviart Farms a hefty \$240,000 at the Hoosier Classic sale last fall.

**Famous Father** made it a natural hat trick for Nancy Taster with her famous father Jimmy along for the ride. After a stalking trip, the elder Takter tipped the Father Patrick colt to the outside as they straighten up and he went on by willingly. Goran Falk and Christina Takter are partners on the son of their broodmare Hollywood Hill.

**Balance** made it four straight for the Taker barn when Scott Zeron drove him to an impressive front running 1:53.3 / :27.1 win over Two Proud (A. Miller) with something left. The Bettors Delight colt from West Of LA, producer of horses that have earned more than \$3 million, is owned by Diamond Creek Racing and was bred by Bob McIntosh and CSX Stable.

David Miller drove the Nifty Norman trained Cantab Hall filly **Fortunapedia** to a 2:02.3 win over stablemate Seven Shadows (Dunn). Ross Stables bred Fortunapedia, who was purchased from the Standardbred Horse Sales for \$30,000 by current owners Patricia Stable and the trainer.

Nancy picked it right back up with "One For The Thumb" in the seventh with homebred **Always B Idyllic** (Dunn) who set a steady pace then sprinted home in :27.2 for the 1:54.1 win over a late moving Treacherous Dragon (Tetrick). Christina Takter, Marvin Katz and Brixton Medical own the Always B Miki filly from the million dollar winning race mare Idyllic Beach.

Mrs Taylor was a 2:00.2 winner for Yannick Gingras for the Burke barn, sliding up the inside through a :29.1 last quarter for the score over Giza Dreams (Zeron) and Unmistakable (Tony Alagna) with Agro Dolce (D. Miller) flashing sneaky late foot to be fourth. The winner is by Muscle Hill from the great Buck I St Pat, who Burke trained to an over \$2.3 million career.

Midnite Express G (Tetrick) closed out the day as Nancy Takter's sixth winner of the morning. Tetrick held the Donato Hanover filly just off the lead as Jaya Bae (Marcus Melander) set comfortable fractions and when tipped and asked, she responded willingly. Just Bee Awsome (D. Miller) closed up nicely to get the place under a grip while the early leader held for third. Midnite Express G is owned and was bred by Misty Ridge Stable.

## Cattlewash and other thoughts

Cattlewash caught my eye again on Saturday night (July 10) when he won the \$250,000 Graduate Series Final. I admit I'm fascinated by his name, which derives from the name of a famous beach in Barbados, perfect for a son of Somebeachsomewhere.

But far beyond his name, Cattlewash is proving that a horse can stand for a full breeding season and then come back and race successfully. Other horses have both bred and raced in the same year, but it's still the exception here in North America. In Europe, however, it happens all the time, and frequently with success in both endeavors. Obviously, the Europeans have mastered the logistics a dual career entails.

Not so obviously here, but in the case of Cattlewash, his owner Bill Donovan, and his trainer, Ron Burke, were able to master the details. (Which leads me to a non-sequitur, i.e. the definition of genius — the ability to master infinite detail).

All of which led this kid to take a look at Cattlewash's pedigree. Turns out he's inbred 3 by 3, to Matt's Scooter, which may have something to do with his obvious racing ability. Which, if you remember, is the horse's phenotype, which is the visible horse. What we can't see is Cattlewash's genotype, which is his genetic makeup, and will determine, for better or worse, his ability as a sire.

I'm not here to write an ad for Cattlewash, or any other stud, but as an objective observance, that double cross up close to Matt's Scooter could be meaningful to him as a sire. RE: his pedigree, he's also linebred, 4 by 4, to Cam Fella, who was one of the very few true sires of sires.

Further back, in the fifth generation, and too far back to have any real significance, both Meadow Skipper and Most Happy Fella each appear three times. And at the very bottom of the fifth generation is the mare Scotch Jewel. Today her name means "nothin' to nobody", as we say in the hills of Kentucky.

But long ago, the first 2:00 horse this kid ever raced, Tiger Lily Lobell p,2,T1:59.3, battled it out week after week in the pacing filly stakes with Scotch Jewel. She was owned by Castleton Farm, and trained and driven by Ralph Baldwin. How appropriate that she is the fourth dam of a world champion in Cattlewash.

That brings me to the first standardbred who ever appeared in my life, a little brown mare named Jean Scott. This happened when I was 11. Although I still was showing my walk-trot pony, Smooth Sailin'; I had that year graduated to a full-sized, threegaited horse, Dipsy Doodle, He doubled as both my equitation horse as well as my mount in the open amatuer (am-at-er) classes. If he'd had a little more front action we'd have been more successful in the classes where he was judged, as opposed to the horsemanship classes where I was.

In those days, in central Pennsylvania where I lived, every wide place in the road put on a least a one day horse show, and every show included a class for roadsters under saddle.

Jean Scott was a little standardbred mare, probably 15 hands at most, owned by Red and Ma Ziegler, who operated a bar in York, PA. Jean Scott was broke to ride, and at the age of 11 I was enlisted to ride her in the under saddle classes. The obvious thought being, a little rider was perfect for a little mare, and this kid certainly fit that bill.

There was only one hitch in the Ziegler's plans for me and their little mare. Although she was on the small side, she took a good hold of the bit. That wouldn't have been a problem for any grown man, but it was one hell of a problem for me.

The classes at those local shows all went the same way; we jogged in going the wrong way of the ring, then after several times around the announcer would call for a road gait, which was faster than a jog but slower than full out.

Then we'd be reversed to go the right way of the ring. But after we'd jogged and road gaited around the show ring, the announcer would tell us to "Let em' trot!"

My only problem was that by the time we were going full tilt, I was long out of arms. So little Jean Scott was on her own, trotting her heart out, with me just a fast posting passenger. Then we'd be told to pull up and come to the center and line-up. Which everyone in the class did except me, because there was no way I could pull my horse up.

So we'd circle the ring at least three or four more times before Jean Scott took pity on me and pulled herself up. And every time that happened, the announcer, who was the same guy at every little show, would give the same spiel: "Look at that kid go! He's havin' so much fun, he don't want to stop!"

It's been a long time since I graduated in the Great Andover Class of '54, as we like to think of ourselves. Last year we lost 10 classmates, so occasional thoughts of our mortality, for those of us still here, are inevitable.

For me, as an indulgence, I like to imagine waking up, as if from a dream. There's a little brown road mare all tacked up, stamping her foot impatiently as she waits for me to grab a stirrup and swing up so she can take off as fast as horses trot. And if she's there, I'll know it's heaven.





#### Judy Davis-Wilson – executive director of the Delaware Standardbred Breeders' Fund

Just like everything else she does in her life, Judy Davis-Wilson made sure she wasn't late making her debut into the world. She arrived a month early. Being responsible, efficient and hardworking, Wilson would eventually become one of the more relevant women in harness racing.

"When I decided to be born, mother insisted her family doctor deliver me, so she made my father drive over two hours on a Sunday afternoon to Elkton, which was near her family farm in Chesapeake City. She would often tell me I cost her a great Sunday afternoon fried chicken dinner," Davis-Wilson said, laughing.

Born in Elkton, MD, Davis-Wilson's parents were both involved in the sport.

"My father was trainer/driver Olin Davis, and mother was Ruth Bower; a chemist who graduated during the war from the University of Delaware and worked at Dupont. Mom also drove racehorses: she was a female way ahead of her time.

"Her father, a retired pharmacist, bought a dairy farm near where Winbak Farm is located today. It was a beautiful place with waterfront on three rivers.

"My grandfather owned standardbreds as a hobby, which is how my mom got started. One day while at the track with her parents, Ralph and Zoe Bower, mom met her future husband, my father.

"My father was from Clayton, Delaware, and ran a private stable for his uncle, JM Davis. In 1959, he owned and trained a filly called QUICK LADY, who won 12 for 12, moving up the ranks from a C-2 pacer to open classes — culminating with the only stake they had paid her into — which was held at Lexington. She won both heats handily."

With both parents involved in the sport, it is no wonder Davis-Wilson chose to make a career of it. Besides her father,

mother, and grandfather, her cousin, Eddie Davis, was a prominent driver who won over 8,000 races.

"My father insisted I learn something outside of the barn and backstretch so when I was 15 years-old I learned to chart at Georgetown Raceway, and when I was 18, I got a job at Brandywine Raceway where I eventually became a program director

"After I gave birth to my daughter, I spent more time away from the track and more time at home, but filled in as a substitute to keep my license active. When my daughter was 11, I went back to work for the 1980 Brandywine meet.

"I was one of the first in the conversion of programs to digital versions rather than hot type set from eligibility papers and manual charts with the RTS system that eventually evolved into what is now E-Track. This was in 1984 and I worked there until they closed the doors in 1989.

'I also worked at Dover Downs and during the summer of 1988 at Freestate Raceway, having been lured there by the late Race Secretary, Ted Leonard."

Davis-Wilson has owned many standardbreds; one being a

very nice pacing filly named BEATEN LENGTHS, a 3-year-old that competed in the New York Sire Stakes, driven by Ross Hayter or her cousin, Eddie Davis.

"The filly was a homebred out of the mare KITTY S, who I co-owned with my father who trained her. KITTY S had been bred by dad's uncle, J M Davis, and was sold to Hanover Shoe Farms at the estate auction when Uncle Med passed away.

"Hanover then sold her to horseman Larry Marsh. When Larry cut back his numbers we bought her at a mixed Tattersall sale and kept her the rest of her life.

"Currently, I don't own any horses, but my daughter does, so that keeps me close to the horse."

Davis-Wilson went to the Hambletonian Society when they merged with the Breeders Crown opening a joint office, and was responsible for computerizing all the payment records from index cards with Gladys Bell, who meticulously kept them for 40 years in Lexington at the Hambletonian Society. Davis-Wilson was also a major part of undertaking and learning about software and hardware.

"I jokingly say, I really carried my boss, Tom Charter's, camera bags everywhere," Davis-Wilson said, laughing.

"Presently, I work for the State of Delaware as the executive

director of the Standardbred Breeders Fund. In 2001, when Delaware got slots and money appropriated for a Sires Stakes program, I left the Hambletonian Society and returned to Delaware to get the program off the ground. Originally, this was called the 'Delaware Development Fund' back in the '60s and '70s.

"In fact, my mother was on their Board, and I like to say today's fund is, like the phoenix who rose from the ashes.

The current Governor, John Carney, was Secretary of Finance and is the one who really got the ball rolling — increasing the funds to the yearly amount of \$3 million for purses — under the then Governor, Ruthann Minner.

"I have been an active member of USHWA since 1992 and a former national president and treasurer, managing numerous Dan Patch Awards banquets, acting as chairwoman of the USHWA Hall of Fame Screening Committee."


Judy Davis-Wilson is by far one of harness racing's greatest assets and we are very lucky to have her.





Do you have a new racing product? A new harness racing initiative? Do you have an idea for a new method of engaging new members to join our tribe? Sitting around will not change your situation. Young or old, trying new roads can be rewarding. Here is another wild pitch:

Hi, Racing Gang,

I hope this email finds you all healthy and happy. I sure miss hanging out with you folks in the Peanut Gallery at Hazel Park Raceway, or as Pete used to call it, The Post Race Autopsy Room. That was a sad day in 2018 when they closed the doors for the last time. By the way, I only had email addresses for you three. I do not have Teddy B, Mister Scissors, or Jerry the Pretzel. If anyone has their emails, please forward this note.

I want to try an experiment and need four lab rats for the early trials. The lab rats need to be harness horse gamblers. Not surprisingly, you folks jumped into my brain.

I am not even sure if you folks play the pacers and trotters online these days. The sport is not the same sitting by yourself, clicking buttons, watching our devices. That's progress, the world turns, and all that garbage. I still play some harness races, but, honestly, I'm running out of steam (and money).

In the grandstands of Hazel Park, before the technology revolution, we played against each other in the pari-mutuel system. Picking winners and squeezing out a few bucks was difficult, but not impossible. And the grandstands were entertaining.

Who will ever forget the night when Jerry lost a photo finish and bellowed so loud that he inhaled his pretzel? When Teddy tried to give him the Heimlich, Glen laughed so hard he got a cramp in his hamstring and began rolling around the floor, groaning and laughing. The place looked like a MASH unit, with Renee yelling to onlookers, "We need a little triage here." Good times, I miss them.

Or, Mister Scissors, the guy who cut his racing program in half to avoid the temptation of playing outside posts. Nice guy, gosh, he sat with us for several years, and I don't recall him ever mentioning his name. Should any of you know him away from the grandstands or have a way to contact him, it would be great to hear from him.

Gambling on racing these days is a jungle of high takeouts, whales, rebates, computer programs, algorithms, wagering syndicates, and chalk. I read reports of artificial intelligence being used to pick winners, which in my mind will never replace natural foolishness.

Speaking of foolishness, this is my proposal. I want to wager against people like you, try to go a bit retro, and return to more authentic pari-mutuel days where people bet against people. Try to return to when wagering was more social.

I have an idea that I want to try. Maybe I can franchise it somehow and make some cash. Even if it does not work out as a business venture, it may bring some of you back to the sport. Most of all, it will be fun. It is not brain surgery. It is like an ante in a poker game.

My early prototype goes like this. Every Friday morning, I will email you and four other players a link to a racing program for Friday evening at a racetrack. The racetracks will vary. I will select and note four consecutive races that we will play. To play, you wager precisely \$6, and only \$6, on each of these four races. You can place the wagers through a wagering outlet like Xpressbet. You email me and CC the five other players your selections at least an hour before the first race. The guidelines are that we each play the same four races and wager the same amount. You can wager your \$6 per race any way you wish.

Fifteen minutes before the first race on Thursday, all five players join in for a Zoom meeting. I will post and monitor the wagers, and I will post a running total for each player on the screen. We can talk before, during, and after the races. It was always interesting to hear why we selected our horses, what went right or wrong during the races, and anything else that pops into our heads.

The twist to this is more than social. The new component is that you also send me \$20 for each four-race competition. For these experiments, I will act as the bank for this \$100 side pot. The winner of the \$100 is the player who has the highest total return on his \$24 wagered.

For example, let us say that Friday's races are at The Meadows — races 7,8,9,10. Glen wagers his \$6 per race like the rest of us. Glen has a good night. After the fourth race, his choices end up earning \$87 (minus his \$24 wagered) for a winning total of plus \$53, the best of our fearless five. Glen receives the \$100 from our side bet, not to mention bragging rights for a week.

I hope this will be fun. The \$100 from zero takeout side bets will lessen the bite from sharks in the traditional pools. The process will keep us all on the same page. Racing will be more of a social event like the good old days. Heck, maybe Glen will have another hamstring cramp.

#### New Jersey Sires Stakes purses to increase by 20 per cent

The New Jersey Sire Stakes Board of Trustees announced this week that purses will be increasing by 20 per cent for Premier Division races at the Meadowlands Racetrack for the 2022 season.

This means purses for the Premier Division races will be \$240,000 for the finals and then \$30,000 for the legs in each of those divisions. The increases take effect for full fields.

"This is exciting and important for the racing and breeding industries of New Jersey for so many different reasons," said Sires Stakes Board of Trustees Chairman Mike Gulotta. "It is going to once again encourage people to breed to New Jersey sires, to stand their stallions at New Jersey farms, and get people excited about purchasing New Jersey sired yearlings."

The number of standardbred horses bred in New Jersey has risen from 279 in 2017, to 435 in 2018 to an expected nearly 800 in 2021.

According to the latest data from the New Jersey Horse Racing Commission, New Jersey remains a leader in harness racing with well over \$300 million in wagers handled in 2019.

The additional funds will also benefit the agricultural businesses within the equine industry, which include the growing of hay, straw, and other farm products as well as support services.

"With thanks to Governor Murphy, Secretary of Agriculture Douglas Fisher, the Legislators of the Garden State, and the breeders and owners of these amazing horses, we are proud to make this announcement," Gulotta said.

The New Jersey Sire Stakes Program was established by law in 1971 to encourage the breeding of Standardbred horses, the trotters, and pacers familiar to harness racing fans. Because the program offers healthy purses for winning Standardbreds sired by registered New Jersey stallions, it gives stallion owners an incentive to locate their stallions and horse farms in New Jersey. As a result, the program has been instrumental in maintaining more than 100,000 acres of scenic open space around the state.

The New Jersey Sire Stakes Finals races for 2-year-old trotters and pacers were Friday (July 16) at the Meadowlands Racetrack. Sires Stakes races will continue at Freehold Raceway on Fridays or Saturdays beginning Aug. 27 and through Oct. 23, with the Standardbred Development Fund finals being on Oct. 16 and Oct. 23.

# Betterhavemymoney repeats, Stonebridge Helios debuts in Gold

Professional, easy-going, strong, willing — trainers Nick Gallucci and John Pentland called on similar adjectives Friday night (July 16) to describe their 2-year-old pacing colt Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Gold Series winners **Betterhavemymoney** and **Stonebridge Helios**.

The pacers took very different trips around the Woodbine Mohawk Park oval to get to the winner's circle, but they tripped the teletimer in identical 1:51.4 clockings and both looked impressive in the effort.

Starting from Post 6 in the first \$103,800 division, Betterhavemymoney and driver James MacDonald spent most of the mile in the outer lane, had to dodge a breaking Coligny Hanover in the final turn, and laid down a :26.3 last quarter to earn their victory. Kolby Two Step, who did much of the work on the front end, finished one length behind the favorites in second and Erinwood Yves also closed like a rocket to be third. (replay here: Betterhavemymoney)

"I was a little worried when that horse made a break in front of him in the turn, but he handled it like a professional. He does everything right this horse," said Nick Gallucci. "And looking at him as a horse you'd never guess that he could be that quickfooted, but once he gets those legs moving they fly. It's pretty amazing.

"He's very stocky, he doesn't have a lot of leg underneath him, he's big bodied, but when he gets moving he's like a train, everything starts moving in the right direction."

Millar Farms of Stouffville, ON bred and own Betterhavemymoney, who is now a two-time Gold Series winner. The Betterthancheddar gelding also won his division in the July 3 season opener at Woodbine Mohawk Park. Gallucci and the rest of the Millar Farms team had always liked the gelding, but it was a June 25

qualifier clocked in 1:55.2 that made them think he might be something special.

"All along we had an idea that he was a nice horse, but the family hasn't really produced anything as of yet so we were kind of on pins and needles," said Gallucci. "He did everything right all along, you could do anything you want with him in a race. He was always very professional and did his job, but I never really started thinking he could be special until that second qualifier. Obviously he's even gotten better from there."

So long as he is happy and healthy following Friday's race, Betterhavemymoney will make his next start in the July 26 Battle Of Waterloo eliminations at Grand River Raceway.

In the second \$103,800 division, driver Bob McClure hustled **Stonebridge Helios** away from Post 7 and led the field to a :27.1 quarter. Im King Conn took over before the :56.2 half and Camealongway stepped to the lead before the 1:24.1 three-quarters. McClure sent Stonebridge Helios into the outer lane around the final turn and once the colt got an open look at the wire he laid down a :27 last quarter to record a three-quarter length victory. Camealongway settled for second and Bob Loblaw closed well for third. (**replay here: Stonebridge Helios**)

Friday's win was proof of what John Pentland had suspected since Stonebridge Helios arrived in his Dorchester, ON barn in mid-June. Owned by John Fleischman of Ottawa, ON, the colt was trained down by Dirk Simpson in Pennsylvania, qualified once at The Meadows Racetrack on June 15 and then shipped north for his Ontario Sires Stakes campaign.

"John Fleischman called and asked me if I would train the horse, he said he was just about to qualify at The Meadows and would I watch the qualifier. He was impressive in the qualifier and I was happy to take him," said Pentland. "I have done very little. He was in good shape when I got him and he was hung up right, I'm just driving the truck."

Pentland said Stonebridge Helios settled in effortlessly in his new surroundings and would have been competing with Betterhavemymoney in the Gold Series opener if not for a bruised foot he suffered in the paddock after his June 25 qualifier at Woodbine Mohawk Park. The foot issue put a wrinkle in the Sunshine Beach son's training schedule, so instead of going postward in the July 3 Gold event he made his Ontario Sires Stakes debut in the July 9 Grassroots test, kicking home in :26.3 to finish second. That result was all the assurance his connections needed to enter Stonebridge Helios for the second Gold Leg.

"He is such a nice horse and he's just absolutely push button. He's a big strong horse, he's the calmest horse in the world, whatever you want, he is happy to do," said Pentland. "I think the colt is for real. He's just so big and strong and happy to do it. There's no issues. He just strikes me as a colt that is for real and might be able to hang around all summer."

Unlike Betterhavemymoney, Stonebridge Helios is not headed to the Battle Of Waterloo eliminations. The colt will return to Gold Series action on Aug. 14 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

## 'King,' Venerable complete NJSS sweeps at Big M

**King Of The North** and **Venerable** both impressed in taking their respective \$200,000 finals of the New Jersey Sire Stakes for 2-year-olds on the trot Friday night (July 16) at The Meadowlands as Walner continued his dominance in the series by siring both winners.

King Of The North completed his sweep of the three colt and gelding races (two preliminaries plus the final) after following perfect cover from the five-eighths from the first-over Looks Like Moni before driver Mark MacDonald tipped KOTN off that tow as they turned for home.

The 'King' had to deal with a stubborn Looks Like Moni through most of the stretch drive before finally putting that one away inside the sixteenth pole. Temporal Hanover and Majestic J finished well to grab second and third, respectively. Looks Like Moni was fourth. When King Of The North, a colt, stopped the clock in 1:52.4 – a new lifetime best – he was 1¼ lengths ahead of his closest pursuer.

"He's got a good kick," said winning trainer Ray Schnittker. "They want to go better if they come from off the pace. He's in the [Peter] Haughton and all of the major stakes moving forward."

King Of The North paid \$6.40 as the 2-1 favorite while staying perfect in three lifetime starts.

Venerable, also three-for-three lifetime, was a dominant winner in the split for fillies as she lowered her previous lifetime best by two seconds to 1:52.2 in completing her three-race sweep. Jiggy Jog S was second with Delilah Hanover third.

Driver David Miller was content to sit fourth early with Venerable before darting to the top at the half in :56.3 and the Nifty Norman trainee never had an anxious moment from there, as Miller gave an ultra-confident steer through a final quarter of 27.1 to win by 2 lengths.

"I talked to Nifty all winter and they were together from the get-go," said David McDuffee when referring to Venerable and Delilah Hanover. McDuffee is part of the group that owns both

fillies. "They both have the [Jim] Doherty in two weeks. The good thing about Venerable is she's a Kentucky bred, so she'll be down there for a while in the sire stakes."

How does one go about acquiring such good horses?

"It wasn't hard," said a smiling McDuffee. "All you have to do is spend \$600-\$700,000."

Venerable returned \$3.60 as the 4-5 public choice.

**KEEPING PACE:** In a pair of non-betting events contested before the regular program, Great Vintage sired both winners of the \$100,000 NJSS Finals for 2-year-olds on the pace.

**Not So Evil**, driven by Pat Berry and trained by Pat's wife, Traci, completed a sweep of the two preliminary legs as well as the final with a third straight open-length score in the filly division, hitting the wire five lengths to the good over Dry Ridge Cutie in a lifetime-best 1:56.2.

**Polaris Breech** took the colts and geldings split to record his first win in three lifetime outings for trainer Chase Vandervort. Tim Tetrick guided the gelding to a 5¼-length score over Dry Ridge Caldwell in 2:00.2. Vintage Valentino was seeking a three-race sweep of the series but was scratched lame shortly before the start.

**A LITTLE MORE:** Lovedbythemasses rocked the clock in a highend conditioned trot. The Jeff Cullipher trainee came from off the pace to score in a lifetime-best 1:50.2 to equals Beads' mark for the fastest trotting mile of the year in the sport... Todd McCarthy guided three winners on the card... All-source handle totaled \$2,681,103.

## Fuzzy Angel and Tipsy In Dixie repeat in OSS Grassroots action

Grand River Raceway's Ontario Sires Stakes season got off to a quick start on Friday (July 16) as **Fuzzy Angel** rocketed around the Elora oval to a 1:56.3 victory in the first \$22,150 3-year-old trotting filly Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Grassroots division.

Starting from Post 4, driver Jody Jamieson fired Fuzzy Angel away from the start and reached the quarter-pole in :28.1. The filly opened up a six length margin on the field by the :57.3 half and had extended her lead to 10 lengths by the 1:26.3 three-quarters. From there Jamieson shifted Fuzzy Angel into cruise and the fan favorites sailed home seven length winners over A Blue Blood and Stonebridge Strong. (replay here: Fuzzy Angel).

"She was awesome today, boy. I don't know what the track record is there, but she was trotting around there so good maybe she could have done something about it today," said Jamieson, who drives the filly for trainer Blake MacIntosh of St. George, ON and Hutt Racing Stable of Malvern, PA. "She's such a half-mile

specialist. Too bad they're not all on the half-mile tracks for her, because she can trot the turns so well."

Jamieson piloted Fuzzy Angel to a track record effort in the Grassroots season opener, circling Clinton Raceway in 1:58.4 on July 4. The Archangel daughter was four-fifths of a second shy of the Grand River Raceway speed mark.

Jamieson was back in the winner's circle after the second division, taking another front-end tour with **Pixies Lady**. From Post 1 the duo clocked fractions of :27.4, :57.3 and 1:26.4 on their way to a 1:57.1 victory. Top Of The Bar finished four and one-half lengths behind the favorite in second and All Muscle N Sass was two more lengths back in third. (**replay here: Pixies Lady**)

"She got a little tired tonight, but I let her trot the third quarter pretty hard to make sure there was nobody chasing us down to get the win," said Jamieson. "That's a big mile tonight too, 1:57.1."

Susanne Kerwood trains Pixies Lady for M. And L. Of Delaware LLC of Wilmington, DE and the Acton, ON resident spent a significant amount of time working with the Muscle Mass daughter after her July 1 start in the Gold Series. The filly dragged Jamieson to a :55.1 half before running out of steam and fading to ninth.

"She won two starts ago in a maiden in 1:55.4 (June 24) and was controllable, and then she wasn't controllable her last start (July 1). Susie's done a heck of a job to get her back where I can drive her and make her do what I want to do," said Jamieson. "You can steer her and things like that, but when she sees the starting gate she kind of loses her mind."

**Edgewater** was behind Pixies Lady in that high speed half on July 1 and did not enjoy the experience, leading her to Post 6 in the third Grassroots division on Friday night. Like the other two winners, Edgewater went straight to the front, rang up fractions of :29.2, :59.3 and 1:28 and sprinted home a three and one-quarter length winner in 1:56.4. Lifeintheslammer finished second and Fortune Tellers K was well back in third. Favorite Radical J J made an early break that took her out of the action. (replay here: Edgewater).

Rick Zeron of Oakville trains and drives Edgewater for his co-owner Jim Walker of Port Perry, ON and said the Kadabra daughter is finally delivering the results he always expected from her.

"When she was 2 she was my best trotting filly in Florida and she got sick on her way back from Florida. She lost a ton of weight and I could never get her to put the weight and muscle tone back on, which in turn ruined her two-year-old year," said Zeron. "What she is now is what she would have been at 2. Everything I wanted her to do tonight she did. She leaves the gate like a pacer, she gets you out of trouble, makes the driver more comfortable, I can't say enough about the filly, she just did everything beyond what I thought she would do tonight. I was very, very happy with her, and I am more happy for Jim Walker to get one to have a little bit of fun with."

The final Grassroots division went to Muscle Mass daughter **Tipsy In Dixie**, who controlled the pace from Post 1 for driver

Two \$50,000 divisions of Ohio Sires Stakes (OHSS) for 3-yearold pacing fillies were featured at Scioto Downs on a humid Friday night (July 16).

**Dragons Lucky Lady** proved that she was just that as she cruised to a 1:52.2 clocking in the first split for driver Tyler Smith and trainer Eddie Foulk. The daughter of Dragon Again notched her seasonal fourth victory from nine starts, upping her 2021 earnings to \$58,335 for owners L&L Stables of Springfield, OH and William A Hartt, of Carmel, ME. Leaving the gate as the 4-5 favorite, Dragons Lucky Lady prevailed easily over 7-1 Babs Jansen(Kayne Kauffman), with 9-2 She Knows It All (Ronnie Wrenn, Jr.) garnering third-place honors.

Bred by Vernon J. Mast of Ohio, Dragons Lucky Lady is the first foal out of the Million Dollar Cam mare Precious Cammill

p,5,1:51.4s (\$247,471) and now has \$78,272 in career earnings from 12 wins, six seconds and two wins in 21 career starts.

**Summer Touch**, the 1-2 favorite, notched her third straight Ohio Sires Stakes triumph this season with a 1:51.2 score in the second OHSS division. Chris Page was at the lines for trainer Ron Burke behind the Well Said lass, who is owned by Burke Racing Stable, Knox Services, Slaughter Racing, and Weaver Bruscemi. With a career bankroll of \$385,660 and seasonal earnings of \$100,110, this standout filly has ten lifetime wins and two seconds from 14 starts. Leave Her Wild, a 14-1 longshot, was second for Mike Wilder, with 34-1 longshot Wall Said (Cameron McCown) third.

Summer Touch, a homebred, is the fourth and most prolific foal out of the Real Desire mare Real Touch p, 3, 1:51.1 (\$150,251); and is a half-sister to: Tru Lou (by Sweet Lou) p, 3, 1:49.1f (\$158,261); Real Fine (by Bettor's Delight) p, 3, 1:52.1f (\$145,118); Touch Of The West (by Western Ideal) p, 4, 1:52.1f (\$86,482); and to the 2-year-old colt Seaside Way (by Downbytheseaside) p, 2, Q1:57.4f.

## Breeders Trophy Series at Hippodrome 3R

The spotlight today (July 18) at the Hippodrome 3R will be on the opening round of the Breeders Trophy Series for 3-year-old colt and filly pacers. There are three divisions, one for the colts and two for the fillies.

All of the youngsters competing are earning points during the three preliminary rounds to be one of the eight finalists in the \$65,000 finals on Sunday, Sept. 12.

The show gets underway with the very first race on the program being the first leg of the Breeders Trophy Series for colt and gelding pacers.

There are nine starters in the slugfest that could be the best race on the card today.

The Light Speed heads the lineup as the gelded son of Moon Beam is undefeated in four starts for trainer/driver Guy Gagnon. He starts from post four and in his last start at Rideau Carleton he was at his best, scoring a lifetime mark of 1:52.3. He was bred and is owned by Michel Nolette of Princeville.

Also in the field is Yves Filion's Cadillac Bayama from the rail post position. This son of Sunshine Beach won three times last season for earnings of \$42,000 for Bayama Farms of Saint-Andre-D'Argenteuil, the fastest a lifetime mark of 1:53.4 at Mohawk Park.

This year Cadillac Bayama is winless in three starts, losing the toughest one by a nose in an amazing 1:50.4 at Mohawk Park.

Local favorite Chantee goes from post five for driver Stephane Gendron and is on a three-race win streak for the trainer Maxime Velaye. Bred and owned by Guy Corbeil of Mirabel, Chantee's last start was at H3R, where the son of Shadow Play took a lifetime mark in 1:57.3.

Other contenders include return winner Putins Dart (post 9), four-time winner Diamond Rock (post 7) and Navalny (post 6).

The fillies get underway in the Breeders Trophy Series starting in the 4<sup>th</sup> race where CL Sportsextreme takes on Celia Bayama and Whitemountaincammy.

CL Sportsextreme goes from post two for driver Jonathan Lachance. The daughter of Sportswriter has three starts this season and last week exploded in her division of the Ontario Grass Roots at Mohawk Park, winning in 1:53.1. She is trained by Dany Fontaine for the Leblanc Stable of Saint-Eustache.

Celia Bayama is another top filly from the Yves Filion Stable. She starts from post one with Yves in the sulky. The Bettor's Delight filly won four times last year with earnings of more than \$58,000. So far in 2021 she has yet to win in five starts but was second by a neck at Mohawk Park in 1:54.1.

Whitemountaincammy has been doing well at H3R this season with three wins in her last four starts, all at H3R. She starts from post six for driver Stephane Brosseau and enters the race off a lifetime best 1:57.4 triumph.

The second division of the Breeders Trophy Series for filly pacers is the sixth race where local favorite Platine Alpha (post 2) heads the field for the Alpha Stable and trainer Sylvain Tremblay.

Sired by Control The Moment, Platine Alpha is currently the winningest horse at H3R with five triumphs. Regular pilot Pascal Berube will be in the sulky. Platine Alpha took a record of 1:57 two starts back at H3R.

It will not be a walk in the park for Platine Alpha as starting from post four is Got Sexy Scars. This daughter of Sportswriter may be winless in five starts for trainer Daniel Bulude and owner Bruno Lepage of Beauharnois, who bred the filly, but she has shown awesome speed at Georgian Downs where in her last start she missed winning by a nose in 1:52.3.

Other contenders include D Gs Magicmoment from post five for driver Jonathan Lachance and Clear The Credit (post 6) for driver Samuel Fillion.

And if the stakes action is not enough, H3R hosts a well-matched field in the eighth race Preferred-Handicap Pace. Top pacers Mickeymaksomespeed (post 5), Somewhere Bettor (post 2) and D Gs De Vito (post 6) will be facing the warhorse and four-time Quebec-Bred Champion, Atomic Million AM, who goes from the rail for driver Sylvain Lacaille. Last week Atomic Million AM won at H3R in a pedestrian time of 1:59.

## **Response to Towers**

This letter pertains to your article "The 'wait until next week' harness racing culture needs to go." (full story here). My perspective how to "improve the product" concerns overnight races, not stakes.

In the article, you wrote that "The reason some drivers (and trainers) don't put forth an honest effort in a given week is because they choose not to." WHY? What reason could a trainer, owner or driver of an overnight horse have to not put forth a 100 per cent effort to win every time they race? If we understand the motivation then perhaps we can try to address this.

The first problem to address is the current classification system used at the majority of tracks.

The conditions for overnight races should align the interests of owners, trainers, drivers with the interests of bettors and it does not. Classes do not connect rewarding only **performance in this race today** with the interests of a bettor, for whom all that exists is **performance in this race today**.

In non-winners of money races, losing horses are rewarded by getting to drop class and race easier horses, so there exists incentive to "manage" your horse until you race easier competition. Winning horses are forced to race above the level they earned the money at, sometimes for 3-4-5 weeks. In non-winners of X races, horses may be "managed" to stay in a lucrative class, such as "non-winners of 8 races life" if the purse is high and they can bank satisfactory earnings by finishing 2nd or 3rd weekly.

Those are possible reasons why an owner/trainer/driver could be satisfied by an effort other than what aligns and is connected to a bettor's desire to see the horse they wagered on give a 100 per cent effort to win. I think we all agree that bettors deserve 100 per cent effort and that's what our "product" should be.

We should examine changing the classification system. Reward the behavior you want to see. Find other ways to group horses that align the interests of owners, trainers, drivers and bettors.

How? Today, I suggest using the TrackMaster ratings for aged horses. Let the race secretary create races matching horses of similar ratings. This past weekend The Meadowlands expanded its use of TrackMaster ratings for a few races for aged pacers and aged mare pacers and the races were evenly matched. In the 4 TM ratings races on Friday, (races 8,9,12,13) exactly zero favorites won. Bettors and owners, trainers and drivers should

like those races. Let's try to put 10 horses on the gait that are all of equal current ability in every race.

There are also modifications possible to Non-winners of X races classes if one is willing to examine those races.

Racing like a business is only successful with a solid income stream, produce the best product possible and the revenue will be there. 
