When Rod Hughes officially announced San Pail's retirement in 2015 he and his family, wife Emily and sons Wyatt and Trace, had put their Dunsford, ON farm up for sale and were intending to move closer to Mohawk Racetrack. However, things did not quite go as planned. The farm did not sell until last year and Hughes found himself with fewer and fewer horses to train, down to just four training and six driving starts in 2018.

In October, he and Emily made a last minute decision to go to the yearling sale in Lexington, KY. They had a few yearlings marked down they felt might be in their price range and were pleasantly surprised when Tymal Tarot turned out to be one of them.

"We had him marked down as buy if we could afford him basically, and we ended up at the \$11,000 and we were as shocked as anybody," said Hughes.

"You think you're about ready to step away from the business altogether and then... Literally, it was kind of a last minute thing to go to Kentucky. It was like, 'Let's go and just see, let's go sit by the ring,'" he said. "We didn't know whether we'd buy one or two, we put our hands up for a bunch of them and ended up with this one, so it must have been meant to be."

The son of Kadabra and \$322,271 winner J M Aggie was an apt pupil through the winter and made his qualifying debut at Woodbine Mohawk Park on June 22, finishing third in 2:02.4. Hughes opted to try the gelding in the Ontario Sires

Stakes Gold Series opener at Mohawk on July 4, but the youngster floundered against the top colts and finished ninth.

"I think, just looking back, he's probably two or three weeks behind everyone that's stabled up near Mohawk, just lacking a little bit of experience," said Hughes. "I do still think he has more potential, but yeah, maybe jumped in a little over our head there the first time."

In response, Hughes entered Tymal Tarot in a maiden at Kawartha Downs on July 13 and the pair was elevated to the win when Meeas Dream caused interference to another horse past the three-quarters and was set back to eighth.

"Not the way you want to do it, but we'll take it," said Hughes with a chuckle.

The tour around Kawartha also served as an evaluation point for the gelding. The second 2-year-old trotting colt Grassroots event goes postward at the Fraserville oval this Saturday, July 20 and Hughes wanted to give Tymal Tarot a practice run around the five-eighths mile oval.

The effort reaffirmed Hughes' confidence in Tymal Tarot

and the pair will line up from Post 4 in the third \$23,150 Grassroots division Saturday.

"He's got a nice look about him. He's just a really nice looking colt actually and the more you're around him, the more you like him," said Hughes of the long-legged trotter. "He's very calm, does everything you want. Really hasn't done much wrong all winter training down. He's literally just done nothing wrong so far, so hopefully Saturday doesn't put a blip on that."

This spring, Hughes moved Tymal Tarot to Prince Lee Acres in Uxbridge, ON. After serving as their blacksmith for the last year and helping out with the young horses on occasion, two weeks ago the horseman was asked to join the Prince Lee team as a trainer.

"Ronnie Morales was my trainer, and he wanted to go back to the States and drive horses so we just got these things to the races and needed someone to fill in Ronnie Morales' shoes," said Dan Clements. "(Hughes) has his horse stabled here, so it just worked out well.

"He's a good guy and I trust him and he's good with the young horses, so we started the relationship like two weeks ago. He started out with a bang, with a win in the Gold (July 11), so everything's going well, so far."

Less than a year after thinking he might be finished with training horses, Hughes suddenly found himself with an Ontario Sires Stakes hopeful of his own and a group of talented youngsters to work with on behalf of the Clements family best known for co-owning the legendary Cam Fella and breeding stellar sire Camluck.

"This spring's been very unexpected just the way it's kind of unfolded for me here so we'll just not get the hopes up too high. But, hopefully, it just keeps rolling along and we have some luck," said Hughes. "It's kind of like you get out of sight and you're out of mind with this business, so it was probably a good opportunity for me to step back in and see where it leads me."

Hughes made his training debut for the Clements family with P L Notorious in the 2-year-old pacing filly Gold Series opener at Woodbine Mohawk Park on July 8. The daughter of Sunshine Beach and P L Angel finished sixth, pacing her own mile in 1:54.

Three days later, Hughes harnessed 2-year-old trotting fillies P L Nikita (E L Titan-P L Blue Opal) and She Started It (Kadabra-Jayport Sweetheart) — who is owned by the fractional ownership group Bright Future Racing — in their Gold Series debut at Mohawk. P L Nikita delivered a 1:59 victory with Jody Jamieson in the race bike and She Started It rolled off stride at the head of the lane when Jamieson and eventual winner Massive Flirt powered up alongside her coming off the last turn.

"My Dad's a trooper, if anybody deserves any credit it's him.

I mean, he's just been breeding these things forever and it's nice to see him have a good Ontario Sired, finally. I think P L Hercules (2014) was the last one that won a Gold," said Clements of his 80-year-old father Norm. "So, he's all excited, he's the guy that keeps everything ticking.

"The Kadabra filly, me and my son (Ryan) went to the London sale and bought her and he set up a fractional ownership thing — we did it years ago with Onlineharnessowner. There was like 26 people at the track the other night, they were cheering and then all of a sudden disappointment. It took \$35,000 right out of our hands, we were going to be first or second, I know that, but that's racing."

For his part Hughes is confident She Started It will sort things out, and the horseman has more than a little bit of experience with fractious trotters; \$3 million winner San Pail, the 2011 Horse of the Year in both Canada and the United States, was not the easiest horse to work with as a youngster.

"I think she just got a little lost. And she's a little bit hot and Jody rolled up outside her, maybe she just wasn't used to someone retaking on her that fast or coming at her like that," said Hughes. "I think she'll put it all together here soon."

However the remainder of the summer plays out for Tymal Tarot and the Prince Lee horses, Hughes is grateful to Dan and Norm Clements for giving him the opportunity to renew his career.

Aubrion du Gers, Europe's best gelded trotter, killed in a freak accident in France

Aubrion du Gers (Memphis du Rib), arguably the best gelding in Europe and the runner-up in this year's Elitlopp for trainer Jean-Michel Bazire, died in a freak accident at Bazire's farm on Tuesday morning.

The accident happened at Solemes in France when Bazire's two trotters Aubrion du Gers and Cyrano du Pont (Look de Star) were involved in a yet-unexplained head-on collision that killed both of the horses.

In the \$402,000 U.E.T. Trotting Masters final in 2017, Aubrion du Gers beat champion Bold Eagle and showed he was a horse that could make a serious challenge in every

trotting event around the world.

Ahead of this year's Elitlopp, Aubrion du Gers won 16 consecutive races.

Bazire's star won 46 races in 73 attempts and the 9-year-old's lifetime earnings ended at \$2,849,361.

"We are devastated. He was a fantastic horse, the best that I've ever made contact with," said a very sad Bazire to French media actu.fr.

Aubrion du Gers was scheduled to race in the International Trot at Yonkers on Oct. 12.

Time to do away with interference disqualifications

I once read a column about 20 years ago from long-time and Eclipse-award winning sports writer Dick Jerardi that I often think back to, especially in times of suspect disqualifications. Speaking specifically to thoroughbred racing, the premise of the column was that stewards shouldn't be able to alter race results after the race is over and that the horse that crosses the wire first is the winner. The idea has a great deal of merit and with a couple of tweaks to it could and should be applied to harness racing.

Thoroughbred racing is more cut and dry in that interference is the only way a horse could be disqualified for in-race events. In harness racing, you have horses that could gain unfair advantages through racing inside pylons or racing while off-stride. Because of those instances, there's still a need for stewards to address potential violations at that time based on rules that should be finite (i.e. going inside a specific number of pylons). But for everything else, stop changing race results based on highly subjective and debatable situations.

Hall of Fame driver David Miller is at the center of two high-profile examples to support the concept. The first comes from last weekend's \$450,000 Hambletonian Maturity for 4-year-old trotters, where Miller's drive Custom Cantab was disqualified from 2nd and placed 7th. Having missed crossing the wire first by a nose, there would have been far more of an uproar if the DQ resulted in the winner being taken down rather than the second-place finisher. But still, the decision to disqualify the 4-year-old mare cost the connections of the horse \$112,500 in purse and changed tens of thousands of dollars from winning tickets to losing ones for bettors. The decision itself to DQ the horse was truly terrible.

Into the stretch, Miller was sitting third on the rail with Custom Cantab. Halfway down the lane, Miller angles out an

overloaded Custom Cantab and surges through the stretch to nearly dead-heat with Crystal Fashion for the win. After a lengthy inquiry, the stewards determined that when Miller angled out with Custom Cantab that he interfered with Phaetosive, who in turn caused interference to Six Pack and Fiftydallarbill. There was certainly some confusion with those trailing horses as the replays showed, but none of it should have been attributable to Miller.

It's hard to watch ([replay available here](#)) and come away from it thinking that Miller didn't have clearance. At the time he moved out with Custom Cantab, he was already a good one to two lengths ahead of 58-1 longshot Phaetosive whose race was already done anyway. The subsequent confusion stemmed from the way Phaetosive's driver Brian Sears reacted to Custom Cantab, but neither Miller nor Custom Cantab should be blamed for it. Drivers angle for room with tons less room than what Miller had to work with and without any consequence, and if Sears didn't react the way that he did, it's highly doubtful that any further action would have been taken.

Maybe you've watched the race by now and see my point but feel it's still up for debate as to if what Miller did constituted a disqualification or not. That's completely fine, and it just goes to further demonstrate that whatever your opinion is, what we're talking about is totally subjective and debatable. And in these speculative and subjective scenarios where a bunch of people could all see the same thing differently, how is it fair for results to be changed after the fact?

Of course, this isn't the first time in recent memory that Miller has been at the center of one of these controversial disqualifications. In the \$1 million Hambletonian two years ago, he crossed the wire first with what was the best horse on that day, but was disqualified and placed last when deemed to have caused interference when moving from the pocket. In that race, Miller and What The Hill were said to have interfered with and caused longshot Guardian Angel As to break stride, and that was another instance of alleged interference to a horse that was on its way backwards. Following that race, Miller was interviewed by HRU and let it be known that he didn't agree with the steward's decision. And if Miller didn't agree with that decision, then he almost certainly wouldn't have agreed with the one from last weekend where it seemed tons more innocent than the Hambletonian incident.

Following that Hambletonian, the connections of What The Hill appealed the race results to the New Jersey courts. They were unsuccessful as these appeals almost always are, but at

least there was a route for recourse for the connections. Bettors don't have that option. Even if a race result is overturned off in the future and purse money is reallocated, it doesn't do anything for those who at one time had tickets on what would have turned out to be the winning horse.

The solution is to let race results stand in cases that are based purely on potential interference infractions. If judges determine that a driver drove inconsistently with what the rules call for, then they can fine or suspend that driver based on the violation. That seems like a much better solution than trying to quickly sort through highly subjective interpretations over a foul occurring or not.

In all other sports there has to be clear and incontrovertible evidence to overturn an initial ruling and in theory, racing should be no different. In these two disqualifications it's impossible to say that the supposed infractions clear that burden and few times will they ever. Because of that, it's time to do away with all interference disqualifications.

Can Greenshoe go in 1:48? Plus, how to correct 2-year-olds hitting their hocks and sore in the knees

Atlanta goes 1 1/8 against the boys and loses, no harm done. Greenshoe never disappoints, another awesome performance. Will be in the winner's circle on the first Saturday in August.

Michelle Crawford did a fabulous interview prior to the first race on the card on her Crawford Farms Meadowlands Pace night.

It would be great if the race would go for a million dollars. The show was certainly worth that. Maybe add a sponsor or raise the payments. Do not, under any means, think I am suggesting that the Crawford's put up the balance. They have already done more than enough for our sport.

I hope the harness racing world appreciates the amazing efforts of Joseph Pennachio to keep our sport in south Florida. He has been a major advocate for many years and is giving it his all now that it is in serious jeopardy.

All who know me are aware of my affinity for good food. With what looks like the imminent revival of Illinois racing I am looking forward to a return to DuQuoin and the re-emergence of the World Trotting Derby. With this marvelous event comes a chance to enjoy one of the best kept epicurean secrets in the country. Just a short distance from Carbondale, home of Southern Illinois University, and the closest area to DuQuoin to find a motel, is a sleepy little town called Herrin. There you will find Mary's restaurant, in a house with no signs and as fine a menu as you could wish for. I have seen governors, senators, and congressman as well as George Steinbrenner, Lou Guida, and Charles Sylvester dining there. If your chance arrives don't miss it.

Jason Ash asks: I have a nice 2-year-old trotter that won both qualifiers and in his first two starts made breaks because he was hitting his hocks above the boots. Any thoughts on how to get him cleaned up?

Before you start fooling with his gait, try this: Change from boots to brace bandages and have your harness shop make a leather or rubber hock protector that is long enough to be half under the bandage and still cover the hock. If it's not long enough the first time he hits it he will pull it out from the bandages. Don't be afraid to make the bandage tight. The change from boots should widen out his stride enough to clean him up. There is a 90 per cent chance this will work. If we fall to the 10 per cent two things that will definitely work, first lighten him up in front by 2 ounces for example from a 9/16" half round to a 1/2" half round. Your blacksmith will know what I mean. Then your next step would be to stop him short behind you can achieve this by raising his angle and adding an aluminum shoe. There is literally no chance that these things won't work, good luck.

D. Romano asks: Please refresh my memory if you can. Did Bo Scott's Blue Chip beat Cam Fella in the Monticello Classic? Why do trotters step up when the trainer elects to pull their shoes? What about pulling shoes on pacers?

On Aug. 8, 1982 not only did Bo Scott's Bluechip defeat the 1-5 Cam Fella, he did it by 9 1/2 lengths in the Monticello Classic VIII. Bo was driven by Jimmy Allen and went wire-to-wire. Cam was driven by Pat Crowe.

Not all trotters can trot barefoot. Horses that need a

nominal amount of weight in their shoe to stay trotting are likely to pace when their shoes are pulled. If you are lucky enough to have a great-gaited horse then it's just a matter of physics why removing his shoes (at least 7 ounces of weight) will help. Barefoot, a horse's stride becomes shorter and more efficient getting over the ground quicker and therefore going faster.

The Meadowlands added a new graphic Saturday night that showed that Hannelore Hanover and Swandre the Giant would race without shoes. Both were terrific.

I have seen trainers pull shoes on pacers, mainly at the Red Mile where the surface is so forgiving. I have never taken note of it helping. The pacing gate is so different and unless a pacer has a severely heavy shoe which is quite unusual, (they wear very light steel swedges or aluminum shoes) I can't see going barefoot of any advantage.

Neil Zelkin asks: I am still tingling from Greenshoe's performance in the Dancer. What are the odds that an elimination or the final of the Hambletonian go under the 1:50 mark? When the Grand Circuit comes to the Red Mile Do you think he is capable of 1:48?

I am the "Guru" not Carnac the Magnificent (Johnny Carson). There are so many variables track condition, weather, competition etc. if Michel Lachance were in the bike I would like the chances more as he makes speed. Brian Sears is a finesse driver and although there is no doubt in my mind that the colt has the ability to trot in 1:48 or 1:49, he never guns this colt from the gate. Fast first halves set up world records, so he will be at the mercy of the movement in the race. As for the Red Mile, it's not that much faster than the Meadowlands is today and under normal circumstances it will be a lot hotter on the first Saturday in August in New Jersey than in early October in Lexington, KY. He is a wonderful colt to watch. Let's not worry about world records and hope the colt stays sound and healthy throughout the year. Sometime, somewhere he will put up the numbers.

Harrison LeVan asks: What are your favorite remedies for a 2-year-old trotting colt getting sore in his knees? He is a large horse and still growing.

All 2-year-old trotters are sore in their knees. It's a matter

of how sore and what the horse has accomplished thus far. There is a big difference how you approach the question until you tell me the colt is training or racing.

If a colt gets very sore in July and he still isn't racing, the obvious solution is to turn him out. Two-year-old bones are very porous and if they are noticeably sore, especially in a big colt, without racing you are asking for trouble by going on.

On the other hand, this is a business and if the colt is racing and gets a little sore we must try to remedy the problem. As the season is very long, you do have some time.

Please make note that if you are not sure that this is a colt that could be competitive in the Breeders Crown or Valley Victory, don't waste time and money going on as my solution will be a bit pricey.

My only solution would be as follows: Shut the colt down completely for two weeks, no jogging, no paddock, hand walk the second week if he is calm enough to attempt it. Have your vet inject the upper and lower joints with a hyaluronic acid of his choice, three weeks in a row. At the beginning of the third week you can resume jogging for a week and then try a moderate training to see what you have achieved. If the colt is repairable, this will work. If not, there is always next year. Please don't let anyone talk you into a quick fix like cortisone injections or shock wave therapy as they will work short term and more likely than not hurt a 2-year-old in the long run.

Thanks to all of you for your kind words. I am glad I got so much nice feedback on my things I miss segment. I really enjoyed writing it, and actually got a note from my daughter Lauren giving me the thumbs up. I am going to attempt a column on My Hambletonian Memories for the big dance weekend. I will also handicap the race for you, which right now looks too easy, but it's never as easy as it appears. Great racing again this weekend at the Meadowlands lots of 2-year-old action and the eliminations for the Adios at the Meadows along with some Sires Stake races on an afternoon card. Training young horses a learning experience for Ohio's Dalton Walls

Dalton Walls can go fast, but he's in no hurry.

Walls, who was a four-year letterman in track (sprinter/hurdler) and soccer in high school, is pursuing a career in harness racing as a trainer. The 20-year-old Walls, the son of trainer Bruce Walls, is based at the Darke County Fairgrounds in western Ohio, where his small stable includes unbeaten Ohio Sire Stakes trotter Big Box Hanover.

Since starting his own stable in 2017, Walls has won 14 of 67 races and earned \$126,388 in purses. Walls and Bruce Soulsby are ownership partners on five horses, all trotters.

"For as long as I can remember, I've been at the barn doing stuff," Walls said about his involvement in racing, which began by helping his dad around the stables. "When I went out on my own, Bruce Soulsby has been the force behind me. I owe him almost everything. He really gave me a shot for a young guy. We just keep growing a little bit every year. He and his wife have been really big supporters of me, and I owe them a lot."

Walls did not intend to focus on training horses so early in his adulthood. He went to Wittenberg University to study business management, but the success of the horses he kept as a side project persuaded him to direct his full attention toward racing.

"I always wanted to keep my hand in it, but I saw how tough it could be with the ups and downs of the business," Walls said. "My first year of college, I had a couple horses and was trying to do both, but I was getting stretched too thin trying to do everything. The horses were racing well enough that I decided to take a year and see if I could give it a shot and see if I could get something going. So far, it's been going really well."

Walls plans to continue working on his college degree, now

with a focus on agri-business.

"I want to have something to fall back on," Walls said. "I think that's really important."

Walls enjoys working with young horses, particularly trotters.

"The biggest thing for me is taking young colts that know nothing and watch them develop," Walls said. "That's my favorite thing, developing young trotting colts and watching them grow mentally and physically. I get a lot of joy out of that. It's the most fulfilling thing for me."

So much so, that Walls has no burning desire to drive in races. He has driven 12 times, but only once since last August.

"We focus on younger horses and I don't want my owners having to worry about me learning to drive on these young trotters," Walls said. "There are a lot of good guys out there. I think it's best to let those guys drive and let me just worry about the horses, I think that's more what I want to do for sure."

Big Box Hanover, a son of Uncle Peter—Box Of Dreams, has been a pleasant addition to the Walls-Soulsby stable. The gelding is 2-for-2 this year, with both victories coming on the Ohio Sire Stakes circuit. The horse, driven regularly by Trevor Smith, was purchased for \$13,000 at the 2018 Ohio Selected Jug Sale.

"He was a big, good-looking thing," Walls said. "We thought the price was right and took a shot on him. He's been good to us so far. We're really excited."

Walls was uncertain what to think of Big Box Hanover when he was preparing him for this season's races.

"He never did anything wrong, but he only did exactly what you asked of him and not an ounce more," Walls said. "He was never very impressive. You could kind of tell there was

always more in the tank, but he never gave me much until we started racing. He's done a 180. He just continues to get better.

"I think what has impressed me the most, and I think Trevor Smith would say the same thing, he's really willing to chase horses down. When he's got a target in front of him, he never seems to run out of gas; he just keeps coming. For as big as he is, I really didn't think he would be that fast of a horse. He continues to surprise me and rip off nice quarters and stuff like that. He really gives me everything he's got on the racetrack and that's all I can ask of him."

Big Box Hanover could help the young trainer make a name for himself, but Walls is taking everything in stride.

"I want to get as big as the game will let me, but where I'm at right now, I think it's important that I have enough time to do almost everything myself," Walls said. "The owners are paying me to do a job and pay attention to stuff. If I keep my numbers small, I can put in more quality time with every horse I've got instead of getting stretched too thin and running around too much."

Most importantly, Walls learns more the more he does with each horse.

"The owners letting me make mistakes has been really good for me," Walls said. "They don't lose patience with me and let me take my time and learn the right thing to do. I think making those mistakes has been good for me. Every horse I've had has been a learning experience, whether it's good or bad. That's been huge for me."

Aussie import looks to be best in Gerrity at Saratoga

There is no question in Steve Oldford's mind where Australian-bred import None Bettor ranks among the horses he's owned.

"I've had none better, I'll tell you that," Oldford said with a laugh. "He's kind of the real deal."

None Bettor, owned by Oldford Racing and Joe Pennacchio's Joe P Racing, has won nine of 11 races since arriving in the U.S. at the beginning of February, with his nine victories coming consecutively since third-place finishes in his first two stateside starts.

On Saturday, None Bettor faces seven rivals — including 2018 Horse of the Year McWicked and O'Brien Award winner Jimmy Freight — in the 11th annual Joe Gerrity Jr. Memorial Pace at Saratoga Casino Hotel. The \$260,000 invitational also includes Camluck winner The Wall, Levy Memorial champ Western Fame, Ben Franklin winner This Is The Plan, Confederation Cup winner Done Well, and Ideal Jimmy.

None Bettor will start from post five with Joe Bongiorno in the sulky for his sister, trainer Jenn Bongiorno. The Bongornos won last year's Gerrity with Evenin Of Pleasure.

"We were hoping for a 2-3-4 post, we ended up with five; we'll take it," Oldford said. "It's certainly better than 6-7-8."

"This is going to test him. The timing isn't great (with his schedule) but we want to go. I think Joe and Jenn will have him ready. He's a great horse to be around in the barn, does everything he's supposed to do. He is relaxed when he's out there jogging. We're hoping he stays good and relaxed right up until they say go."

Oldford and Pennacchio, both known for their award-winning amateur driving exploits, partnered on None Bettor after Oldford heard about the horse through a network of connections Down Under. Oldford's success with Australian-bred pacer Stormont Czar, who has earned \$84,125 since his purchase last year, played a role in getting None Bettor.

"We watched his video and liked him and brought him over," Oldford said. "He showed a lot of speed on half-mile tracks and we thought we could make some money with him. I typically buy trotters, but the first one came out well. This one turned out to be a monster. It's just one of those things. We got him for the upper conditions at Yonkers with the hopes he would make the open. He got real good real fast."

None Bettor, a son of Bettor's Delight out of Limerick Star,

had 16 wins in 58 races Down Under. His victories in the U.S. include the Battle of Lake Erie and three legs of the Great Northeast Open Series.

"The Bongornos have done a great job," Oldford said. "They've gone slow with him and brought him along. We really took our time with him and made sure he was ready."

"He's a nice horse. I'm really impressed with his gritty determination. He can sprint off the gate like there's no tomorrow. The way it's been in his recent races, he sets up shop on the front end and just digs in and won't let anybody by him. He doesn't want anybody to pass him."

The Joe Gerrity Jr. Memorial was established to honor the former long-time chairman of the board at Saratoga Raceway. Gerrity was involved in nearly every facet of the sport at some point in his career and instrumental in the expansion of the facility at Saratoga and installation of video gaming machines, even funding part of the project himself. Gerrity passed away in 2005.

Racing begins at 7:05 p.m. Saturday at Saratoga. Following is the field for the \$260,000 Gerrity Memorial, which is race seven on the card.

Love A Good Story, Munster and HypnoticAM win NYSS at Yonkers

On Tuesday (July 16), Yonkers Raceway played host to the humid \$156,600 New York Sire Stakes Hugh Grant Trot for 2-year-old fillies. Three, \$52,200 races comprised the event.

There wasn't much out of the ordinary in the first division. **Love A Good Story** (Andy Miller, \$2.20) sat off some ambitious fractions (:27.4, :57.3, 1:27.4), before moving to the lead and drawing off. From post position No. 3 (in one notch after a defection), she whipped l'lldotitmyself (Scott Zeron) by 3¾ lengths in 1:57.2.

C Me Hyde (Phil Fluet) and Seeking Royalty (Jordan Stratton), 1-2 through those quick early intervals, wound up third and fourth, respectively.

For Love A Good Story, a daughter of Chapter Seven co-owned by Pinske Stables and Kentuckiana Racing Stable and trained by Julie Miller, it was her third (NYSS) win in as many seasonal/career starts. The exacta paid \$32.80, the triple returned \$80.50 the superfecta paid \$573.

"She's just so good," driver Miller said. "She made it look easy."

Tuesday night's second sire stakes rendition saw a determined **Munster** (Stratton, \$5.80) hold off a second pocket-pull of Sorprese (Dan Daley). From post No. 5, the former went the distance (:28.4, :58.1, 1:27.3, maiden-breaking 1:57.4), defeating that rival by a length-and-three-quarters.

Seventimesalady (Ake Svanstedt) was third as the 6-5 favorite, with Olympic Glory (Andy Miller) rounding out the gimmick numbers.

"It was the first time I'd driven her, but she showed she could leave, so I left," Stratton said. "Then she dug in."

For second choice Munster, a Chapter Seven miss trained by Per Engblom for co-owners Black Horse Racing and Wiesman Farms, it was that first win in a pair of season/life tries. The exacta paid \$57, the triple returned \$199.50 and the superfecta paid \$2,422.

It took until the final state-bred soiree for the gauntlet to be thrown down.

Odds-on **HypnoticAM** (Brian Sears, \$2.70) vaulted up and over her six inside rivals—the outside foe was scratched — then had her way in a gapped-out group (:28, :57.4, 1:26.3, 1:56.1).

The final distance between Hypnotic AM and bridesmaid Really Blue Chip (Anthony MacDonald) was 5¾ lengths, while the time was a new track record for the her weight class (Plunge Blue Chip-1:56.2 in '17).

Destiny Blue Chip (Svanstedt, part of entry) was third.

For Hypnotic AM, a homebred Chapter Seven ma'am trained by Marcus Melander for owner Courant Inc., she's started out 2-for-2 after another blowout NYSS win (in identical times). The exacta paid \$24.20, the triple returned \$50 and no superfecta wagering due to the presence of a coupled entry. "Those Melanders do a helluva job," Sears said.

New York Sire Stakes returns downstate Saturday night (July 27), with the Milt Taylor Trot for 3-year-old colts/geldings (purse TBA).

Standardbred Transition Alliance announces website, accreditation application launch

The Standardbred Transition Alliance (STA) has launched its website and with it, the accreditation process for



programs serving standardbreds outside traditional use.

The non-profit 501(c)(3) Standardbred Transition Alliance accredits, inspects and awards grants to approved organizations that acquire, rehabilitate, train and re-home standardbreds, using industry-wide funding.

The site, at www.standardbredtransition.org, contains information about the goals of the STA, the board of directors and a link to the application for accreditation.

The accreditation process examines program operation in the areas of management, finances and horse care. Programs that pass the initial phase will be inspected prior to a determination of accreditation. Accredited programs will be given a grant toward program operating expenses.

Application for accreditation will close in October, inspections will follow; programs receiving accreditation will

be announced early in 2020, with grants awarded at that time.

Preliminary requirements for applicant programs include holding current IRS 501(c)(3) status, caring for at least five Standardbreds a year and at least two years of operation. Details on additional minimum requirements for programs seeking accreditation can be found through the accreditation tab on the website.

"The board of the STA is excited to take this important step toward a system of accrediting standardbred transition programs," said David Reid, STA president. "Accreditation will help ensure donor confidence in programs serving our horses and, over time, will create a steady source of partial operating funds for programs meeting STA standards. Through the process, programs exercising strong and transparent management and horse care practices will grow in their sustainability."

The work of the STA mirrors that of the [Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance](#), which last year accredited 73 programs and awarded \$3 million in grants.

Her time of 1:52.4 eclipsed the prior record of 1:54.1 set by My Tallia Ideal in 2015 for older pacing mares. YS Tallia is now the fastest mare ever at H3R and is tied with Duc Dorleans with the fourth fastest mile ever at the track.

A 5-year-old mare by Western Ideal, YS Tallis is trained by Michel Allard for owner-breeder Yves Sarrazin of La Presentation and paid \$2.30 to win.
