Monticello taken to court over refusal to resume racing

Lawyer Joe Faraldo, representing the Monticello Harness Horsemen's Association, said the casino company that runs the track is refusing to resume racing unless horsepeople pick up the tab.

Joe Faraldo, the lawyer representing the Monticello Harness Horsemen's Association (MHHA), is taking Monticello Raceway's parent company Empire Resorts to court today (July 22) to try to force the New York track to resume racing.

Monticello last raced March 12 before being shut down due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Though all other harness tracks in New York scheduled to race this summer have long since re-opened with the blessing of the state, Monticello, located in the Catskills Mountains resort area, has remained closed.

Faraldo said the issue is casino management is balking at having to pay for the costs associated with conducting racing while the track's affiliated casino, Resorts World Catskills Casino Resort, remains closed to the public.

"(Management says), basically, 'Unless the horsemen give up all of their statutory and contractual revenue streams then we're not going to open... If you don't pay for racing, then we're not going to conduct it,'" Faraldo said.

"We have \$3 million in purses available that we are being deprived of the opportunity to race for. It's not that they don't have the money to pay purses. They continue to maintain the

track, which they are doing five days a week, but they don't want to run any extra cost to bring in personnel, EMTs or any personnel that they need to conduct simulcasting... they don't want to have the expenses of racing."

Faraldo said track management has also told the MHHA that, "if after September 1 our casino opens and our gross gaming revenue drops, then the statutory contributions that we have to make to racing will drop in proportion to our losses sustained in gross gaming revenue."

After Faraldo was interviewed at length, HRU emailed eight questions to a spokesperson for Monticello and received the following answer, which appears in full and verbatim:

"While we await further guidance from New York State, we are hard at work making sure Resorts World Catskills will be ready to reopen as soon as we are able to. Reopening Resorts World Catskills will allow us to get hundreds of employees back to work and play a leading role in supercharging the funding for New York's educational system.

"We look forward to including Monticello Raceway in this reopening process as part of our steadfast commitment to the long-term success of the Catskills."

Faraldo said the Monticello horsepeople have already

suffered through a long shutdown due to COVID-19 and can ill afford for racing not to resume soon. Apart from his concern about the financial health of the Monticello horsepeople, Faraldo also said he has deep concern about the plight of the horses that race at the track, many of which have trouble racing elsewhere because the competition is too steep.

"The guys at Monticello are few and far between that stick their heads into Yonkers, for example. They aren't going anywhere else," Faraldo said. "At Saratoga and other places, you can only race two days a week. The problem is that those horses— and I don't mean to demean anyone about those horses — but it's more of a likelihood that they go to the Amish or they meet some fate that I'd rather not talk about... and end up in New Holland, Pennsylvania."

New Holland is home to a regular horse auction known as the Kill Pen where horses are sold for meat.

Faraldo said the situation is also egregious because Monticello is contractually obligated to race.

"(Monticello doesn't) want to honor any of the obligations that they have, pursuant to law, to run racing," Faraldo said. "Those obligations are in statute for so many race days. For example, the fact that they applied for a license, the fact that

the governor now has said that after June 1 you can have racing at the track, pursuant to the terms of your license. No one can conduct racing without a license, so everyone that has a license is given the opportunity to restore racing.

"I understand that it was impossible to have racing up until June 1 (due to COVID-19), but after June 1, it was no longer an impossibility to perform and so they should be performing – not only because of all the statutory obligations they have to pay purses and for OTB money to be shared et cetera, et cetera, they also have a contractual obligation with the Monticello Harness Horsemen's Association to conduct racing.

"When I look around, I don't think I can find a track in the country that's been permitted to race that hasn't raced, except one, and that's Monticello. Certainly, in New York state, I can look at VLT facilities: Saratoga, Vernon, Yonkers... they are all meeting the obligations in their contracts and under state law and pursuant to the license that they were granted. And they don't have VLTs operating, so what does that mean? That means Yonkers is going into their pockets, Saratoga is going into its pocket and Vernon is going into its pocket. Now, look at Tioga. Tioga has a casino... Tioga is operating (racing), so that means that management there is going into its pocket to operate racing because it's pursuant to a license that they have.

"(Monticello's) casino company has decided that they are going to control the mandate from the governor, the obligations under our racing license and simulcasting license. We're going to transcend any provisions in state law that provides for minimum race days or statutory sharing of money between the horsemen... 'We're going to lock you out,' basically.

Faraldo said there's a virtual court hearing scheduled for today (July 22) at 2 p.m.

"We've asked the judge to issue a preliminary injunction, preventing them from depriving us of our opportunity to earn a livelihood pursuant to that contract and prevent them from locking us out of racing, the existence of racing," Faraldo said.

"Meanwhile, we filed a claim against them in arbitration for approximately \$6 million in damages."

Faraldo said no one, including the New York State Gaming Commission, seems willing, "to enforce any of the rules or regulations covering the conduct of racing at Monticello,

including the number of race days that they've applied for, the fact that they are holding a license to conduct racing and simulcasting, besides holding still a VLT license and their affiliated company has a casino license."

Faraldo said he's concerned about setting a precedent for allowing casino companies to offload the cost of racing onto the horsepeople.

"We're not tolerating any of that," he said, adding that Monticello and others conveniently forget racing is the reason some of the tracks were granted casinos in the first place.

"Before (Monticello) got its casino, we entered into this long-term contract with them which has about four or four-and-a-half years to go. One of the conditions, pursuant to that contract, was that we sign a letter supporting them getting a casino because they thought the horsemen's support was that important... But, like in most places, once you get what you want, you forget the promises that you made. Like 'I love you,' for example," he said.

After nearly 40 years in the game, Tim Twaddle still feels like the kid that first fell in love with harness racing

When most kids his age were listen to bedtime stories, a young, pajama-clad Tim Twaddle was sitting in his mother Pat's car, newspaper clipping in hand, taking in the daily double at Garden City Raceway.

Parked along the backstretch of the racetrack that once stood in St. Catharines, ON, mother and son watched in rapt silence as the pacers or trotters would whiz by, catching a brief glimpse of the pack before they disappeared around the turn.

Twaddle, who would bring along the evening's race selections, recalls those moments as if they happened the night before.

"I guess most kids my age would be hearing a bedtime story, but I was catching the first two races at the racetrack. I had the entries that I had cut out from the *St. Catharines Standard*. On the backside, you couldn't see that much of the action. But I remember [driver] Ron Feagen – he was a big name back then – and his race bike had red wheels. I'd always watch for that."

That fascination with horses, drivers and harness racing would eventually lead to a part-time job at Garden City.

Through his oldest sister, Cindy, who worked in the dining room as a messenger bettor at the racetrack, a teenaged Twaddle penned a letter to local horseman Bill Carroll, asking if he was in need of some help with his stable of horses.

The two met and soon after, Twaddle began working for Carroll on the weekends and during breaks from school.

"I knew very early in life that I wanted to be in the horse business and that I wanted to be a driver," said Twaddle, who earned his driving license in late 1982. "My buddies and I would ride our bikes to the country and we'd find a fence where a horse would come out of its paddock to see us. I

love horses and I love racing. Not too many kids can say they got to grow up and live their dream, but I get to say I did.”

Twaddle’s first night in the sulky didn’t start out in memorable fashion.

In fact, after a pair of out-of-the-money finishes, he sat sullenly in the drivers’ room, wondering if he had made the right career choice.

“It was a viciously cold winter night... December 13, 1982. My mom and a lot of family drove up from St. Catharines to come to Greenwood Raceway. The first two races didn’t go well at all. The first horse, he was coming back from a long layoff. I moved him first over and that was a big mistake. It didn’t work out well. The second one, I was part-owner of him, along with [radio personality] Earl Warren. It was a goofy Great Britain horse by the name of Saunders Storm. He was a pulling, runaway-type horse. I remember John Burns put a lip cord on him, so I’d be able to keep a hold him. Of course, the bugger sulked and he wouldn’t go at all.”

The third and final drive of his debut had Twaddle holding

his head high at the wire.

It also taught a young upstart an invaluable lesson about the racing game.

“I just wanted to give it up after the first two drives. Luckily, the horse I had for my third drive, I had sat behind him for a couple of qualifying drives. We hit it off good, and he ended up paying \$104.10 to win. Everyone who came – my mom and my uncles – bet and made out pretty well. It was a big night. But right then and there, you understood being a driver is all about ups and downs.”

By the early 1990s, Twaddle, who had completed his college studies, had risen up the ranks to become one of Canada’s top drivers, handling horses for the powerful John Burns Stable. He drove the Jugette and Breeders Crown winner Towners Image, and Breeders Crown winner Hardie Hanover.

In the late 1990s, he moved to The Meadows – Hall of Fame track announcer Roger Huston convinced him to come – where he became a sought-after catch-driver.

Twaddle also spent time on the California circuit, but returned to The Meadows in the fall of 2006.

“I had planned to go to Dover. I was in the dining room at Woodbine, and I ran into [fellow driver] Luc Ouellette. He

said he had heard I was going to Dover. He said, 'We're going to have a great time.' I thought, 'I don't need to go there and be second fiddle to Luc Ouellette. I can stay here at The Meadows and be second fiddle to Dave Palone.'

"After that, I was approached by some people to drive in California at Los Alamitos. I didn't think too much about it, but a guy I drove for at The Meadows, Bob Ritchie, he said every winter they bring some horses out there. So, I went, and I got 20 bucks a drive. I had a lot of fun. Through going out there, I ended up meeting the lady who I would end up marrying."

Twaddle, along with his wife Sophia and their children, daughters Meadow and Lexi, and son Parker, have called Canonsburg, PA, home since the fall of 2006.

Along with training horses for Hold The Line Stable, Twaddle conditions for other owners. Currently there are 25 horses in the Twaddle Racing Stable. Some of those horses, about a dozen of which he co-owns, include Goggles Paisano, Dapper Dude and Donatover.

He also trains for the Thestable.ca, the fractional ownership stable headed by Anthony MacDonald.

But it hasn't always been a smooth ride for Twaddle, who became a U.S. citizen in 2008.

Injuries, some of them serious enough to send him to the sidelines for an extended period of time, denied him the chance to gain more wins, more notoriety and more opportunities.

One accident, ironically, ended up saving his life.

"I got banged up multiple times in Ontario, and coming back time-after-time, it got tougher and tougher for me. I shattered my hip in an accident at Flamboro in 1985. During the surgery, doctors discovered I had a leaky valve in my heart. They found an aneurism that was the size of a softball. Had that accident not have happened, I might not be around today. I ended up getting a cardiologist, who then put me in touch with a great surgeon in Toronto. It was a great blessing the way it happened."

Finding work after being out for months proved to be a frustrating challenge.

Despite being cast into the spectator role, Twaddle, whose sister Robin — who ran the Terrace dining room at Greenwood and went on to work at Woodbine during the Ontario Jockey Club era — moved back to the Niagara region from Vancouver to help with his convalescence, didn't lose his passion for the sport.

He also didn't lose his sense of humor.

"If you ever want to make God laugh, tell him you have a plan."

While his original blueprint didn't pan out, Twaddle's ability to chart new paths over the course of his career has paid off handsomely.

Nearly 1,950 driving wins, including a 1991 Metro Pace score with Shipps Saint, and over 750 training triumphs, provide ample proof.

Not bad for a once wide-eyed kid who watched horses rush by from a backseat car window, rain, snow or shine.

And now, after 40-plus years in the sport, Twaddle, inducted into the St. Catharines Sports Hall of Fame in 2017, still has that very same awe and reverence for horses and horse racing.

"I remember the feeling I'd get when I was in the car with my mom [now 93-years-old], just loving every second of what I saw, even if it was a quick glimpse. After all this time, that feeling hasn't changed. Every single day, it puts a smile on my face."

Takter, Gingras savoring Meadowlands Pace triumph

Under most circumstances, trainer Nancy Takter would have watched the stretch drive of this past Saturday's Meadowlands Pace and been overcome with a sinking feeling. In those instances, though, she would not have been watching Tall Dark Stranger.

Tall Dark Stranger and driver Yannick Gingras captured Saturday's \$636,650 Meadowlands Pace in dramatic fashion, giving up the lead to rival Papi Rob Hanover in the stretch before fighting back to win by a neck in 1:47.2. Few people – including Gingras, co-owner Buck Chaffee, and Takter's father Jimmy – thought Tall Dark Stranger would be the winner as the horses began their battle on the final turn.

Takter, however, was undaunted as the scene unfolded.

"Usually when a horse kind of halfway clears, your heart sinks," Nancy said. "I never got that feeling. I never had the feel that I was the loser. It was the weirdest thing ever. I watched the stretch and I had so much confidence in Tall Dark Stranger and knew he would come back.



"What a champion he is. He just doesn't want to lose. He's just a great horse."

Nancy won her first Meadowlands Pace in her second try. In 2019, she finished fourth with favorite Captain Crunch. Tall Dark Stranger also gave the Takter family its first Pace trophy; Jimmy sent out 10 horses in the event for 3-year-old pacers with a best finish of second with Vintage Master in 2009.

As is a Takter tradition, the winner's blanket was placed on a bronze horse statue near the entrance of the family's central New Jersey farm.

"There have been a lot of great blankets out there, so it was about time that one got on," 39-year-old Nancy said. "When I was growing up, a little kid, Meadowlands Pace night was always a big event. My dad didn't have a lot of pacers at that time, but I remember all these great horses and we would talk about them. I knew it was special to win the Meadowlands Pace."

Tall Dark Stranger was the 2019 Dan Patch Award winner for best 2-year-old male pacer. For his career, he has won 11 of 12 races and earned \$1.05 million for owners Crawford Farms Racing, Marvin Katz, Caviart Farms, and Howard Taylor. Tall Dark Stranger was bred by Jim Avritt, Sr. of Kentucky and sold to his current connections for \$330,000 at the 2018 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale out of the Hunterton consignment.

The colt, a son of Bettor's Delight out of Precocious Beauty, is Gingras' second Meadowlands Pace winner. He got his first Pace victory with A Rocknroll Dance in 2012.

"I have a connection with Tall Dark Stranger that makes it a little different than with A Rocknroll Dance," said Gingras, who has driven Tall Dark Stranger in all his qualifiers and races as well as spent time with the horse at Takter's stable. "Then, you have the expectations. A Rocknroll Dance was 9-2 and things worked out on that day, but you don't have the pressure.

"Tall Dark Stranger, he's the champ, he's the one that has to be dethroned. He was 1-2 (odds), it was a lot of pressure. And I know Papi Rob Hanover is a great horse. I knew he would show up. Everyone saw Allywag Hanover, he's super-fast too. You put all that together, to be able to get the job done, in that fashion too, is a great, great feeling."

Papi Rob Hanover and Allywag Hanover both looked poised to defeat Tall Dark Stranger after the latter went for the lead in a :25.4 opening quarter-mile, then reached the half in :53.2 and three-quarters in 1:20.4. Around the last turn, Papi Rob Hanover pulled even with Tall Dark Stranger, with Allywag Hanover following Papi Rob Hanover's cover.

"When Papi Rob came, I really didn't feel like I was a winner there," Gingras said. "I thought I was beat. I knew (Allywag Hanover) was in a perfect spot; I thought I was in trouble with both of them. I thought I would be second or third at that point. I just kept trying to keep my horse alive and he just fought.

"Halfway down the stretch, I thought I had a chance. Maybe like a hundred feet before the wire, I knew I had (Papi Rob Hanover) even though I wasn't back in front of him yet. I knew I was getting to him and I had time to get him too. It felt pretty good then.

"Tall Dark Stranger is a winner and he knows what he has to do to get the job done. He has the desire to dig down deep and give you that little more that's needed."

Winning driver Yannick Gingras said, "When Papi Rob came, I really didn't feel like I was a winner there... I thought I was beat."

After winning eight of nine races last season, Tall Dark Stranger is 3-for-3 in 2020 and has two sub-1:48 miles already this year. His 1:47.2 clocking in the Meadowlands Pace ranks tied for eighth best by a 3-year-old pacer in history.

Gingras believes the horse's strong start this year is in part due to the way he finished last season. Tall Dark Stranger's connections decided to quit with the colt following his win in the Breeders Crown rather than pursue nearly \$600,000 in purses in the Matron Stakes and Governor's Cup.

"They could have kept on going last year, but they quit with him after having a great year with him," Gingras said. "They decided they were going to focus on trying to put all the chances on our side for his 3-year-old season, and it paid off. They got rewarded for their patience. I think the credit goes to them and Nancy for doing a good job bringing him back."

Tall Dark Stranger's next start is expected to be in the Tompkins-Geers Stakes on Aug. 1 at The Meadowlands. Then comes the Cane Pace the following Saturday at The Big M.

In the meantime, Nancy Takter will savor the Pace triumph.

"I was a little disappointed about last year, so it was nice to come back and get it done this year," she said. "It's a very special accomplishment."



Next Direction erases Varenne's stakes record

The 1:50.4 mile recorded in the \$160,000 St Michel-ajo is the fastest by a Finnish-bred trotter in history.

Varenne's stakes record in the \$160,000 St Michel-ajo in Mikkeli, Finland (1:51.2), was erased by a homebred trotter on Sunday afternoon.

The mile race on the acknowledged fast track in Finland became a solo show by Orlando Vici son **Next Direction** and driver Iikka Nurmonen. The duo left quickly for the lead, held high pace and the opponents were never really invited to the show.

First choice, Italian horse Vernissage Grif, paired with trainer Alessandro Gocciadoro, found a perfect spot in third over, but a strong home stretch wasn't enough from their part, since Next Direction, already had hit the wire as winner, basically.

Second choice Missile Hill went off stride before the car left

the field of 8 trotters and St Michel-ajo became Next Direction's from the moment the start went off. If it felt like a revenge or not is hard to tell, but the Timo Hultkonen-trained horse finished second to Makethemark in last year's edition of the race and Makethemark, who had to do the heavy job first over, held to third place this year for Ulf Ohlsson.

Next Direction won in 1:50.4, the fastest mile ever by a Finnish-bred trotter.

Diana Zet came back on

The \$530,000 Stochampionatet for 4-year-old mares bred in Sweden was held at Arevalla racetrack on Sunday afternoon and a heavy cloudburst, just 10 minutes ahead of the card's most prestigious race, caused some problems for drivers and horses.

Stefan Melander-trained Ganga Bae (Muscle Hill) has belonged in the top of the crop since she won an elimination for Oaks last year and her main antagonist has been **Diana Zet**, who won Oaks and even Drottningpokalen earlier this season. The two mares came to Stochampionatet's final after safe victories in their respective eliminations, and after the draw, it was clear that Diana Zet (Hard Livin) once again had better luck since she got post 3 while Ganga Bae started from post 5.

Örjan Kihlström sent Diana Zet to the front, which left driver Jorma Kontio with no other options than to put Ganga Bae on the leaders outside.

The weather, in addition to the fact that the two favorites were side by side early in the race, made the Stochampionatet an undramatic story where no other horses, or drivers, had intentions of attacking three wide searching for better position. So in the last turn, Ganga Bae got her head ahead of Diana Zet and Kontio seemed to have power left in his horse. But Diana Zet came back on when Kihlström pulled the ear plugs from his trotter and Diana Zet cruised to a safe length win in a mile rate 2:01.1 over 1.6 miles.

Award Kronos (Father Patrick), was served a nice trip in third over by Adrian Kolgjini and the duo claimed the bronze medal.

The victory in Stochampionatet pushed lifetime earnings over \$780,000 for Daniel Redén's homebred horse. Redén and his Stall Zet owns the sire Hard Livin – who also is the father of rookie trotter Don Fanucci Zet in the same barn – and Diana Zet's mother Marsia L.B. has been successful in breeding before. Her first offspring In Toto Sund (Ken

Warkentin), born in 2012, won the Breeders Crown as a 4-year-old and ended her career with earnings of \$556,000.

Kihlström claimed his seventh win in the Stochampionatet and thereby equals champion trainer and driver Stig H Johansson's record in the race.

John Campbell responds to You Make The Call, urges commissions to adopt rule changes

In our July 12 issue ([full story here](#)), we posted a video of a NYSS race at Yonkers and asked for your take on the judges' ruling. We posted some of your feedback in our July 15 issue ([full story here](#)).

After the July 15 issue, Hambletonian Society president John Campbell wrote in with the following feedback:

I would like to belatedly comment on your You Make The Call feature regarding the 4th race at Yonkers on July 7. The issue was an extended run in the stretch.

In 2017, I formed a committee to revisit the racing rules in the USTA rule book.

It was made up of a cross section of people from within the industry drivers, judges, racetrack operators, horsemen association representatives and the executive director of a racing commission.

We made several rule change proposals to the USTA in 2018 and 2019.

I have to commend the USTA and their board for being very open and receptive to what we were trying to accomplish.

We wanted the racing rules to be more concise and definitive and thus make it easier for judges to make decisions and also paint a clearer picture for participants and horse players.

One of the rules that we addressed was the extended run rule.

It was proposed and passed by the USTA that: An extended break shall be defined as a horse that is not on its proper gait for 25 strides or more.

This rule was also passed into Model Rules by the Association of Racing Commissions International [ARCI]. However, to my knowledge, The New York State Gaming Commission and most states have not adopted this rule.

If this rule was in effect, there would have been no debate as it was clear the offending horse was off stride for well over the 25 stride limit.

USTA rules also state that: Committing an extended break, in which the horse may be placed last.

Using strides to determine an extended run is not unprecedented as France uses 15 strides to determine whether a horse is disqualified or not.

I would also like to bring up another rule that we proposed and was passed by the USTA as well as adopted into model rules at ARCI.

This involves a race with multiple trailers, as was the case last week in the Hambletonian Maturity.

The rule states: In a race with a single trailer, the driver may select any position in the second tier.

In a race with multiple trailers, the driver of the first horse in the second tier may elect to score out behind the first or second horse in the first tier.

The horse drawing the second post in the second tier shall score behind the third or fourth horse in the first tier.

The horse drawing the third post in the second tier shall score behind the fifth or sixth horse.

This gives the drivers of horses in the second tier more options in regard to strategy, it is safer and reduces the risk of a recall due to interference before the start of the race.

Again, this is not unprecedented as many jurisdictions in Europe use this protocol.

I do not believe that many states have adopted this rule either.

While we were reviewing our racing rules in the United States, Standardbred Canada was spearheading a similar movement as well.

They have made recommendations to all of their jurisdictions regarding racing rules that either mirror or are similar to what we presented and were passed by the USTA and ARCI, including these two rules referenced above.

There is an avenue for racing rules to be very similar throughout North America, we can only hope that enough jurisdictions take advantage of this and as I stated earlier paint a clearer, more consistent picture for fans, participants and judges.

A closer look at the Indiana casino revenue and its impact on racing

As the delayed Harrah's Hoosier Park race meet kicked off in mid-June, one of the underlying concerns focused on casino operations at the state's two pari-mutuel racetracks. Would slots players return once the facilities reopened in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic? According to reports posted by the Indiana Gaming Commission, early indicators show that slots business was strong in an abbreviated month of June.

Racing stakeholders had reason to be optimistic in 2020. Table games were offered for the first time at Hoosier Park and Indiana Grand beginning January 1. During the months of January and February, Hoosier Park alone generated adjusted gross revenue totaling \$19,709,152 and \$20,583,764, respectively. However, the pandemic forced the closure of all casino operations in the state on March 16. Final adjusted gross revenue for those first 15 days of the month reached \$9,886,990 at Hoosier Park.

Casinos remained closed until June 16, and revenue from the partial month of operation were recently made public by the IGC. Adjusted gross revenue at Hoosier Park totaled \$9,670,509 in June, down slightly from March figures. While March and June figures do not represent full months, the results for last month are encouraging. As part of Indiana's reopening plan, casinos were allowed to open their doors, but restrict capacity to 50 per cent. With that in mind, Hoosier Park's June casino business is a great start to restoring the momentum of earlier in the year.

The strong start was not limited to Hoosier Park. When reviewing statistics for Indiana's 13 casinos, the June numbers were similar across the board. Together, the outlets combined for \$183 and \$192 million in adjusted gross revenue in the opening months of the year. In June, AGR reached nearly \$102 million.

Indiana's racing industry receives 12 per cent of adjusted gross revenue from casino operations at Hoosier Park and Indiana Grand. That money is allocated to purses, breed

development programs and horsemen's associations. With three months of zero revenue (two full months and two half months) flowing from casinos, all groups had to tighten their belts and reconfigure 2020 programs to account for the loss and the uncertainty of future months. After seeing the early returns, stakeholders hope this isn't just a short-term spike. Instead, they are optimistic that business will continue to trend upward as those seeking entertainment return.

Semi Tough too tough for M Life Rewards series rivals

Semi Tough dominated his rivals in the \$60,000 M Life Rewards Gents Series Final on Monday (July 20) at Yonkers, leading all the way through blistering fractions of 26.3, 54.4, 1:21.4 and stopping the clock in a lifetime best 1:50, just two-fifths of a second off the track record.

Semi Tough is a 4-year-old gelding trained by Ron Burke and driven to victory by George Brennan. Semi Tough had made two recent starts in the Graduate series and has now earned more than \$540,000 lifetime.

Yonkers Raceway wrapped up two stakes finals Monday night which saw more than four months pass between preliminary legs and finals.

The M Life Rewards Ladies and Gents Series' began in the first week of March but were interrupted when racing was halted for three months due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Top performers from the legs that were held in March qualified for the \$60,000 finals.

In the M Life Rewards Ladies Final, **I'm Very Special** blasted to the lead from post position eight and never looked back, winning by two and a half lengths in 1:52.2. North Star Ideal finished second and Red River Jane was five lengths back in third.

I'm Very Special notched her fourth win of the season for trainer Peter Pellegrino and owners Melvyn Colby of Great Neck, New York. Jason Bartlett was the winning driver.

Captain Corey sets track, stake records in career debut at The Meadows

Freshman trotter **Captain Corey** may have been making his pari-mutuel debut in Monday's (July 20) \$208,721 Pennsylvania Sires Stake (PASS) at The Meadows, but it took

him only 1:54.1 to rewrite the record books. With that mile, the son of Googoo Gaagaa—Luv U All became the fastest 2-year-old trotter ever at The Meadows... and shattered the stake record to boot.

The event known as the Hickory Pride was contested over three divisions, with Type A and In Range taking the other splits.

While Captain Corey's performance was electrifying and marked him as a colt to watch in the 2-year-old trotting division, trainer/driver Ake Svanstedt said it came as no surprise to him.

"He got home very well in his qualifiers," Svanstedt said. "He's a huge horse. I think he's one of the best young horses I've ever trained. He's staked everywhere."

Captain Corey powered to the lead and put the field away with a :27.4 third quarter. Plumville Prince rallied for second, 4-1/4 lengths back, with Tart Tongue third. The mile erased the track record of 1:54.4 held jointly by Sutton and Giveitgasandgo and wiped out the stake record of 1:55.2 that Whats The Word and Real Cool Sam shared.

SRF Stable, Knutsson Trotting and Midnight Sun Partners campaign Captain Corey.

Type A also was a facile winner on the front end, defeating Take All Comers by 1-3/4 lengths in 1:56. Johan Palema completed the ticket.

"I thought he was the horse to beat in there for sure," said winning driver Yannick Gingras. "I didn't really want to follow anybody. He might not be as quick as some of the other ones, but he never gets tired."

Nancy Takter trains Type A, a son of Southwind Frank—Up Front Laura, and owns with Frank Canzone.

In Range was sitting behind sluggish fractions when Tim Tetrick sent him on his way. The son of Bar Hopping—Ilia zipped to the front and prevailed in 1:57.1, 1-1/2 lengths better than Bacardi. Fly Light earned show.

"When I moved him, he marched right up there and did the job right," Tetrick said. "It's still a game to him; he's out there playing around. But every time I talk to him, he's got more speed, so I'm very happy with him."

Marcus Melander conditions In Range, who has opened his career with two straight stake victories, for AMG Stable, Kenneth Kjellgren, Tomas Ansell and Rick Wahlstedt.

Captain Corey wasn't the only youngster to set a stake

record. In Monday's sub-feature, **Arnold N Dicky** waltzed to a 16-3/4-length romp in 1:55.1, bettering Savini's previous stake mark of 1:56.4. Dave Palone piloted the son of Bar Hopping—Kalibrated for trainer Chuck Sylvester, who owns with Amy Stoltzfus, Neal Goldman and Gilbert Short.

Trainer Julie Miller and driver Andy Miller teamed for a stake double with **Sunny Crockett** and **Lindys Goin Crazy** while **Lepanto** and **Think I Can** took the other splits.

"Youthful veteran" driver Anthony Napolitano recorded the 3000th victory of his driving career Tuesday afternoon (July 21) at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono with a hard-earned victory behind the Artspeak sophomore pacing miss Winning Words. The favored filly had to go the difficult first-over route, yet held off a host of distaffs coming from every direction to take a new mark of 1:53.4.

The 38-year-old Napolitano, brother of local top reinsman George Napolitano Jr., is currently in the 20th year of his sulky career. His horses have won over \$1 million for twelve consecutive years, including the last five years with their earnings each being over \$2 million. His best money year came in 2018, when he handled the winners of \$3.5 million. Anthony has also won over 200 races in each of the last four seasons, with his yearly high in 2009 at 295.

Anthony currently ranks fifth in victories and third in money earned among the talented Pocono driving community.

Bet On Becky, Andra Day grab Gold win number two

Bet On Becky extended her win streak to three on Sunday with an effortless 1:53.3 victory in the first \$108,000 2-year-old pacing filly Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Gold Series division at Georgian Downs.

The Bettors Delight daughter and regular reinsman Jody Jamieson eased away from Post 2 and settled fifth as stablemate Ring Of Kerry led the field of 10 to a :27.2 quarter. Heading by the grandstand for the first time Bet On Becky buzzed to the front, reaching the half in :56.2, and it was smooth sailing from there for the fan favourite. Off a three-quarters in 1:25, Bet On Becky cruised home a three and one-quarter length winner in 1:53.3 City By The Bay finished second and Ring Of Kerry was third.

"I even think we could do okay with (Jody driving) her," joked trainer Tony Beaton. "She did it with relative ease again, by the looks of things. Jody was real happy with her too, so that's good."

In the July 7 Gold Series season opener at Woodbine Mohawk Park, Bet On Becky delivered an impressive 1:50.4 victory, still the fastest mile clocked by a 2-year-old in North America this season. She also posted a 1:54.4 win in an overnight event at Woodbine Mohawk Park on June 26. With those two starts and a June 19 qualifier under her belt,

Beaton gave his fledgling star a mini-vacation before prepping her for Sunday's test.

"We kind of gave her an easier week there last week and then we trained her up pretty good there the other day and tried to make sure we had them ready for tonight," said Beaton. "She showed she was ready anyway and, actually all four of them raced pretty good tonight. I was happy with all of them, but obviously Becky just stands out."

In addition to Bet On Becky and Ring Of Kerry, Beaton trainees Turning The Table and Best Keepsake finished third and fourth in the other Gold Series division.

All of the fillies save Best Keepsake are eligible for the July 27 Battle Of The Belles eliminations at Grand River Raceway and Beaton said that will be their next start so long as they remain happy and healthy. Bet On Becky is eligible to all of the major 2-year-old pacing filly stakes in Ontario and has an action-packed schedule ahead if she continues to find the winner's circle with the ease she has demonstrated in her first three starts.

"Becky is going to have a long, long season ahead of her if everything goes good. She's paid into stuff right to the Breeders Crown," said Beaton, adding that filly will not be able to appear in every stake she is eligible for. "We don't want to over race her, we've got to pick our spots. We'll take it week-to-week and go from there. We've got to stay healthy and sound before we do anything else."

Beaton trains Bet On Becky for Larry Menary of Branchton, Kenneth Ewen of Georgetown, Alan Alber of Thornhill and Michael Guerriero of Brampton, ON. The partners offered up \$70,000 for the filly at last fall's Lexington Selected Yearling Sale and have recouped \$97,633 through her first three starts.

Andra Day also picked up her second Gold Series victory with a front end effort in the other \$108,000 division. Starting from Post 5, Andra Day left smartly and was moving forward from third when Turning The Table reached the :27.3 quarter. Comfortably in front at the :57.4 half, Andra Day soon faced pressure from fan favourite Best Keepsake, who challenged her through the 1:26.1 three-quarters. Andra Day remained resolute however, and held off all challengers to score a three-quarter length victory in 1:54.1. Scarlett Hanover closed hard to be second and pocket-sitter Turning The Table was third.

"She's small, but very tough and very, very gritty," said trainer Dr. Ian Moore. "She is very fiery, and just all go, so we're very pleased with how she's done."

Moore trains the Shadow Play daughter for Let It Ride

Stables Inc. and Bottom Line Racing LLC of Boca Raton, FL. Guelph resident Doug McNair was in the race bike for Sunday's victory and her 1:54.1 win in the Gold Series season opener.

Like Bet On Becky, Andra Day is eligible to the Battle Of The Belles, but Moore is not sure if the filly will compete in the eliminations or look ahead to the next Gold Leg at Woodbine Mohawk Park on August 18.

"I'll be talking with the owners. She might be the only one, because she's small and probably will handle the half. I won't take the other one because she's a great big filly," said Moore of Andra Day and stablemate Alumni Seelster, who finished fifth to Bet On Becky Sunday after winning her division in the opening leg. "It's a possibility, but right now I'd say 50-50."

Ontario Sires Stakes action returns to Georgian Downs on Sunday, Aug. 16 with the third Grassroots Leg for the 3-year-old trotting fillies.

Think Of Galaxies then let it loose as they headed for home. It was then a battle for second as Think Of Galaxies glided home in 1:53.2. Test Of Faith finished second with Spicy Covina (Tyler Buter) getting third money.

Baby trotting fillies in All-Stars action at Pocono

The freshman trotting fillies **Pub Crawl** and **Insta Glam** added Pennsylvania All-Stars victories at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono on the Sunday twilight card after winning a Pennsylvania Sire Stakes at The Meadows in their previous start.

Pub Crawl raced first, and the daughter of Bar Hopping—Myth and thus the possessor of a strong maternal line for generations, moved to the lead early for driver Andy Miller, got a soft half, then came home in :57.1 to hold off pocket-sitting DD's Diamond by $\frac{3}{4}$ of a length in 1:56.4. Julie Miller conditions the winner for the Andy Miller Stable Inc., Louis Willinger, Kapildeo Singh, and Phillip Helmuth.

Insta Glam, the fastest Sire Stakes winner with a 1:55 triumph, was not expected to emerge with the same honors here after a rainstorm turned the track to "sloppy" and lowered the mercury 11 degrees for her final All-Stars division. However, Insta Glam definitely was in command in a :57.2 last half through the off going, defeating pocketsitter Evening Stroll by $1\frac{3}{4}$ lengths. A daughter of Father Patrick out of Hollywood Hill, who has a millionaire mother and half-brother, Insta Glam is owned by Goran Falk and Christina Takter and was backed by driver Yannick Gingras and trainer Nancy Takter – who had teamed for a famous victory 21 hours earlier.

The \$600,000 yearling **Ineffable** (by Cantab Hall out of the 1:52.1 world champion Jolene Jolene) recorded his first victory in the fastest of the four \$30,000 All-Stars divisions, making two moves to control the pace then fighting off the stretch threat Flawless Country by a nose in 1:56. Brian Sears, top driver on the card with three victories, drove the chancy filly for the Melander Machine and owners Menhammar Stuteri AB and the S R F Stable.

Cantab Hall picked up a second siring credit with **Mazzarati**, who had been just a neck behind in third in Pub Crawl's Sire Stakes victory. Here the daughter of \$1.3M-winning mare Falls For You followed the front ones in the 3-spot against the pegs until the three-quarters, then trotted to the fore in the lane to win by $1\frac{1}{4}$ lengths over Myreanna in 1:57.1. Tim Tetrick was in charge of the winner for trainer Lucas Wallin and the Mazza Racing Stables Inc.

Despite pause, Buffalo Raceway has good season

The COVID-19 pandemic threw a monkey wrench into every racetrack's season with Buffalo Raceway being no exception.

Closed from March 14 until June 3, Buffalo Raceway did get in 28 live race dates out of the 66 that were scheduled and performed quite well considering.

"It was a trying meet but overall was successful," Buffalo Raceway operations director Jon Cramer said. "We were off to a great start until the pandemic forced us to close. Thanks to the support of everyone, we were able to open quickly and maintained a safe and clean environment. We could not have done it without the cooperation from the New York State Gaming Commission, the Western New York Harness Horsemen's Association, all of the horsemen, staff and our fans."

Cramer said that before the shutdown, the daily average on track wagering was up 10 per cent. For the season, pool totals were up 50 per cent with much of the increase coming in June and July.

Billy Davis Jr. captured his second consecutive Buffalo Raceway driving title and his third straight on the Western New York circuit. He collected 70 wins on the season and earned \$376,644 in purse earnings. He easily beat out David McNeight III who finished second with 41 victories.

"It's nice to win it again," Davis Jr. said. "I was consistent throughout the year and it helped teaming up with trainers **Maria Rice** and Sabrina Shaw who had some good horses for me to drive."

Davis Jr. said of the layoff, "I'll tell you I was chomping at the bit to get back. After the first night coming back, I was a little sore the next morning."

Maria Rice took her first training title ever and said, "I never thought it was possible until a couple of years ago. It's

pretty cool to win it, I'm not gonna lie."

Since arriving on the Western New York circuit seven years ago, Rice and her husband Jack have 23 horses in their barn which made winning a championship more realistic.

"We've been in this for some years now and when we first started out we had like seven horses and we shipped all over," Rice said. "We never thought of winning a title because of that. The past few years, when you have 23 horses, you think about winning the title a little but never think it is possible."

"When the pandemic hit, it was business as usual for us. We didn't have to lay off anyone and our horses stayed fit and happy."

Rice finished the meet with 39 victories, a UTR of .353 and \$242,962 in purse earnings. She beat trainer Gerry Sarama by 14 victories, 39-25

Davis Jr., who was the 'first call' driver for the Rice barn said, "It's great that Maria won the trainer's title and it's nice to be able to share it with her."

In the 'Pacer Of The Meet' competition, **Daylight Rush** took the top honors for the 2020 campaign.

Since returning to the track after the pause on June 6, Daylight Rush had three wins and four seconds in his seven starts. His four runner up finishes were less than two lengths combined.

With a seasonal mark of 1:55, the 7-year-old gelded Daylight Rush (Art Colony—Pass With Caution) is owned by Cassandra Johnson and was trained and driven by David McNeight III. He completed the Buffalo meet with \$28,850 in earnings and has a career bankroll of \$247,334.

There was little doubt who the 'Trotter Of The Meet' was going to be as **Bred For Greatness** was just great all season long.

Winning seven times in nine starts against the top level sidewinders, Bred For Greatness earned \$39,315 on the year, by far the highest purse earnings at the track for either gait. He enjoyed a four-race win streak until July 8 when Victoria Swan pinned a three-length loss on him.

Co-owned by trainer Michael Ohol and Steven Gross, Bred For Greatness (Federal Flex—Wendy Woo) had Jim Morrill Jr. and Kevin Cummings share the driving duties. The 6-year-old gelding had a seasonal mark of 1:58.1 and has produced \$125,596 in lifetime earnings.

In race statistics, the post time favorite won at a clip of 40.17 per cent while the one spot had the most victories with 84 in 356 races while the four post was next with 68.

Live racing is tentatively to resume in January, 2021. Simulcasting in the clubhouse will remain closed until January 1, 2021.

Atta Boy Dan becomes millionaire with Pocono victory

Atta Boy Dan, the 2019 Horse of the Year at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono, added another chapter to his already-burnished historical record when he went over a million dollars in lifetime earnings with a Monday afternoon (July 20) victory at the mountain oval.

George Napolitano Jr., his companion in so many victories last season, got the 11-year-old Western Terror gelding into fourth early, then moved first-over against pacesetter Nine Ways. The pacesetter didn't make it easy for the greybeard, but Atta Boy Dan showed his class by going on to a $1\frac{1}{4}$ length victory over that foe in 1:51.3 for owner Stephen Larkin and trainer Pete Pellegrino.

The victory boosted the lifetime earnings of Atta Boy Dan to \$1,002,084; he now has 76 career victories in 214 trips to the gate. The winningest U.S. harness horse in 2019 with 19 victories, Atta Boy Dan also set an unofficial record by being claimed out of 14 straight starts, and 17 times in total at the Pocono meet last year, for a total of \$670,000. Larkin and Pellegrino were the last of the claimants, and they have seen their horse win over \$44,000 already this year despite the limited opportunities.

George Napolitano Jr. finished with five winners on the card, including two each for trainers Pete Pellegrino and Tom Cancelliere.

So Rude (Jim Morrill Jr.) and Merga Hanover (Matt Kakaley) both have NYSS wins this season and should be the major contenders in the second division.

So Rude (So Surreal) is trained by Jennifer Bongiorno. She won a leg of the NYSS at Yonkers and finished second to Merga Hanover at Tioga Downs. She has two wins this season and four career victories with earnings of over \$150,000 in her lifetime.

Merga Hanover (American Ideal) got her first win as a sophomore with a NYSS victory at Tioga Downs. She has seven career wins and has earned over \$200,000 lifetime. The filly is trained by Ron Burke.

Vernon Downs will start the 15-race card at 4 p.m.

Owners can attend lives races at Batavia Downs

When the Batavia Downs live racing meet gets underway on Wednesday (July 29) there will be no fans in attendance due to concerns surrounding COVID-19. However there will be one exception.

Listed owners of horses in to go will be allowed on the track apron starting opening night. General spectators or guests of owners will not be allowed onto the grounds until further notice as per New York State Gaming Commission regulations.

If you are going to have horses racing this meet and would like to watch them in person, please take note of the protocol that needs to be followed in order to do so.

Listed owners must make a reservation to attend in advance and be put on a list that will allow them to enter. Reservations must be made 24-hours before race time. The number to call to make a reservation will be on the Batavia Downs Facebook page and also the overnight sheet once the first draw is completed. Listed owners who register will receive e-mail confirmation and security will only let in those that have registered and are on the list.

Upon arriving at the Downs, a temperature check and health status questionnaire must be completed by each listed owner in the lobby. Once that process is complete you must then proceed through Park Place to the apron. No one is allowed to walk through the gaming floor to the apron.

Masks must be worn at all times and social distancing is required and will be strictly enforced. Also there will be no food or beverage service available.

Listed owners will be also be allowed in the winner's circle for pictures if their horse wins but anyone doing so must remain masked and observe proper social distancing.

Also please be aware that owners coming from states that are on the New York State Coronavirus Quarantine List are not allowed to attend at any time.

"Shenandoah Downs is a unique meet. Fans not only support the meet in great numbers but create an exciting atmosphere by cheering for horses that win and even those that don't win. I know they will be disappointed to hear but the decision was made with the safety of fans and participants in mind. We plan to be back to normal in 2021."

Even though they can't attend in person, fans will still be able to enjoy the races via video streaming at www.shenandoahdowns.com. Post times have been adjusted as well. Both Friday and Saturday programs will start at 2 p.m. to remain consistent.

In a normal year, the Shenandoah County Fair harness races would precede the Shenandoah Downs race season by two weeks. Four programs had traditionally been conducted during the Fair, which usually ends the Saturday of Labor Day weekend. One week ago, the Fair itself fell victim to the

COVID-19 pandemic and was cancelled for 2020.

Even though the Fair won't be held, the Virginia Harness Horsemen's Association decided to move forward and conduct a three-day campaign during that same time frame called the "VHHA Matinee Meet". Races will be held Wednesday, Sept. 2, Thursday, Sept. 3 and Friday, Sept. 4 at 2 p.m. The same protocol will apply: races will not be open to spectators. "We're considering it a prep meet for the five-week extended season," said Dee Lineweaver, who serves as Racing Secretary for both. "We're happy to provide horsemen with another three racing opportunities in this challenging year."

Important horsemen info for Spirit Day at Plainridge

Owners, trainers, drivers and grooms who will be coming to Plainridge Park on Sunday (July 26) for the \$250,000 Spirit of Massachusetts Trot and \$100,000 Clara Barton Distaff Pace are asked to take note of the following information before coming to the track as much has changed due to state of Massachusetts regulations relating to COVID-19.

The draw for Sunday (July 26) will be held today (July 22) with the box closing at 9 a.m. Also today, you will need to fax to the judges a 2020 negative coggins test, a 2020 EHV vaccination record and an up to date health certificate with Plainridge Park as the destination for each horse racing.

There will be limited access to the administration building and as a result, anyone needing a 2020 Massachusetts racing license is urged to apply in advance. Go to the MGC website, download the appropriate form and fax it to the judges prior to coming to Plainridge to keep the number of people who need access to the licensing office to a minimum on race day. If you are unable to do that, print and bring the completed form with a check made out to the Massachusetts Gaming Commission to the track to expedite the transaction on site.

The fax number for sending health certificates or licensing forms is (508) 643-9624. The phone number to contact the judges directly is (508) 576-4565.

There is no overnight stabling on the grounds at Plainridge Park this year, so you will not be able to get into the track before Sunday morning (July 26) at 8 a.m. All horses in to go

must be on the grounds no later than 11 a.m. and then get to the Lasix barn at the appropriate time for your race.

All horses will have assigned stalls and must remain in those stalls until the races are over. At the conclusion of the card, all horses must then leave the grounds.

No one is allowed in the paddock except for the trainer of the horse and a groom. No owners will be allowed in the paddock. Also no one will be allowed in the winner's circle after any race except the winning horse and the driver.

To enter the grandstand you must go to the main casino entrance, have your temperature taken, answer a health questionnaire and then proceed to the racing side of the building. A mask must be worn upon entering Plainridge Park Casino and must be kept on the entire time you are there. Social distancing is also a requirement and will be enforced.

Also due to state COVID-19 restrictions, the grandstand will be limited to a maximum of 300 people. If you are planning on attending, tickets will be available the day of the race at the program stand or from any racing services manager for \$5 (limit two per person). Please note there are a number of tickets reserved for participating horsemen that day.
