Growing stakes in the Garden State

With \$240,000 New Jersey Sires Stakes finals for 2-year-olds set for tonight at The Meadowlands, the state's breeding industry has rebounded.

The New Jersey Sire Stakes (NJSS) program had one foot in the grave as recently as nine years ago, but thanks to the efforts of Meadowlands' president/chief executive officer Jeff Gural and the Garden State legislature, it's now full of life.

"Everything feeds off The Meadowlands," said Mike Klau, syndicate manager for Southwind Farms in Pennington, NJ. "Without that, none of this would have happened. Kudos to Jeff for stepping in. None of this happens without him."

Prior to Gural's acquisition of The Meadowlands, the number of stallions standing in New Jersey was on the decline. So much so, that in 2013, there were only four in the entire state, resulting in only 74 mares bred and 47 foals born.

"Frankly, we stood Muscle Hill in New Jersey and then, basically, were forced to move him when the sire stakes basically collapsed," said Klau. "There was no money in there and we moved the horse to Pennsylvania for a couple of years but we brought him back when we thought that the sire stakes were coming back."

According to the Standardbred Breeders & Owners Association of New Jersey (SBOANJ), there are currently 18 stallions standing in the state, 13 pacers and five trotters.

The numbers of stallions have increased dramatically," said Mike Gulotta, chief executive officer of Deo Volente Farms in Flemington, NJ. "On the trotting side, in addition to what we have – Six Pack and Propulsion – you have Walner, Tactical Landing and Muscle Hill in New Jersey, so that's a significant population.

"Now, because of the significant help from the legislature and the governor – the purse appropriation – there have been many more stallions than there used to be and there are many more mares bred in the state. Which brings increased tax revenue to the state, so it basically pays the state back for the purse appropriation."

In 2019, the New Jersey legislature passed a bill, which was signed by Governor Phil Murphy, appropriating \$20 million, divided evenly between thoroughbred racing and standardbred racing, for five fiscal years to aid purse accounts.

"The numbers of mares bred has been on the incline for five years," said Klau. "In fact, right before the appropriation was approved by the legislature, just the hint that it was coming increased the numbers.

"More mares are coming. More stallions are coming. It's been a trend upward, which also is great to show that the legislature was right in supporting our industry."

New Jersey offers breeders awards, a New Jersey-sired overnight bonus and resident-mare rebates, and on the trotting end, it's top notch, but both Gulotta and Klau would like to see more elite pacing stallions come to the state to join Lazarus N and Perfect Sting, both standing at Deo Volente.

"If you look at what we have, Lazarus is, of course, a Bettor's Delight and Perfect Sting is an Always B Miki," said Gulotta. "So, what would be interesting is getting something in the Somebeachsomewhere line to fill in the diversity of lineages."

Klau has questioned why Southwind can attract such in-demand stallions as Muscle Hill, Tactical Landing and Walner, but not a pacing equivalent.

"It wasn't like we weren't trying to get pacers," said Klau. "We were all trying to get pacers. I was told having The Meadowlands as the premier mile track is more important for trotters than pacers. I mean, I could make a case that for the pacers it's just as important."

The NJSS trotters now have finals for \$240,000, up 20 per cent over last year, and with the edition of the New Jersey Classic series for Jersey-sired horses in September, a trotter can stay in the state of New Jersey and race for \$540,000. Pacers race for less because there are so many fewer of them.



Lazarus N is currently dominating the 2-year-old pacing NJSS and Gulotta's looking forward to what Perfect Sting's progeny will do in a few years as breeding and the sire stakes program in the state continue to rise.

"It's clearly dramatically improved with the purse appropriation and sports betting," said Gulotta. "Prior to the advent of those developments there was obviously concern. Things were extremely lean and they're much, much better now.

"As an example, George Segal and Marty Granoff, who owned Perfect Sting before he was syndicated and they still own a significant piece, they decided they wanted to put the horse in New Jersey because there's a lot of opportunity in New Jersey and little in the way of competition. There are so many reasons to be more excited today than you could have been even five to seven years ago."

Each year, the SBOANJ must submit a report detailing how the appropriation was used, but that's not all they have in the hopper.

"We're working on putting together a horse industry economic impact study to present to the legislators to give them more of an overview of what else the industry does not only from what the appropriation has done for us as a group but what the industry does within the state and how it adds to the revenue base from taxes and things of that nature," said Al Ochsner, SBOANJ executive administrator.

Even though 2023 is the last year for the appropriation and a new bill would have to be passed for a new appropriation, listening to Governor Murphy's own words bring hope.

In an interview at The Meadowlands in 2021 on Meadowlands Pace Night, he referred to The Meadowlands as an iconic track not just in New Jersey, but in America, and said in part: "Conceptually, passionately, we will continue to be there for this industry. This industry is too important. There's too much at stake, both in breeding, in handle, in jobs, in attendance, in open space. For all the above reasons, New Jersey's all in in this industry."

Firefighter and horseman Steven Fedokovitz hoping to build a Bigly career

Whether he's in uniform or his racing colors, Steven Fedokovitz always answers the call.

The majority of his days can be a question mark in terms of how they will play out, but for the 19-year-old standardbred driver/trainer and volunteer fireman, not knowing what to expect when he wakes up each morning isn't necessarily a bad thing.

"It definitely makes life interesting. I think with both jobs, although they are much different, there is an adrenaline rush that you find. They both keep you on your toes and they prepare you to handle whatever comes your way."

Hailing from Slippery Rock, a borough in Butler County, PA, Fedokovitz has embraced his unique lifestyle, one that can include a little bit of everything from the time the sun rises until it sets.

His harness career, in its early stages, is keeping him busy as he learns the ropes.

Fedokovitz's affinity for standardbreds and standardbred racing was picked up from hours spent in the barn of his grandfather, Dennis Youshock.

"I got into racing through my family. My great-grandfather, he was the one who started out working with the horses, then my grandpa started doing it as well. My mom was going to get involved, but her allergies bothered her too much, so she wasn't able to do it. I was at the barn with my grandpa since the time I was three. And it just stuck with me ever since. I enjoyed it right from the start and it's stayed with me over the years."

That love of all things racing eventually led him to the barn of driver and trainer Aaron Johnston. Working for the horseman who has compiled a combined 500-plus wins has been an ideal learning resource for the teenager, who had started out as a groom.

The same can also be said of Fedokovitz's time spent with Johnston's band of trotters and pacers, a group that includes Bigly.

A 3-year-old trotting son of Cantab Hall—Miss Fidget, Bigly, an original \$8,000 purchase (Hip No. 494) at the 2020 Lexington Select Sale, has become a favorite of the young horseman.

The consistent brown gelding, sporting a mark of 7-2-5 from 19 races, along with over \$60,000 in purse earnings, has helped Fedokovitz develop his confidence level and skill set since they were paired together.

"I started helping Aaron do some training, and I started jogging some horses. Bigly is probably my favorite horse. He's an

incredible horse and Aaron has done well with him. This is a trotter who definitely knows what he's doing. It's kind of cool getting to sit behind a horse like that, a consistent horse who always shows up. When Aaron brought him back from being turned out in the winter, I was doing a lot of the training with him and I would get to go a training mile with Bigly. I learned a lot."

Bigly also holds special significance for Johnston. On April 29 the duo crossed the wire four lengths ahead of the nearest rival in 1:55.4. The victory marked the 200th lifetime driving win for Johnston.

Another horse who has had a major influence on Fedokovitz is a trotter by the name of Dakota Dawne.

Owned by his grandfather, the 6-year-old daughter of Triumphant Caviar—Cant Get Over You has made nearly 70 career starts, and recorded nearly \$50,000 in earnings.

"I started out with her, and she helped me a lot. I was able to learn a lot of different things about horses from her."

These days, Fedokovitz isn't grooming as much as in times past, focusing instead on ramping up the driving and training aspects of his career.

"I help out Aaron and work in his barn every day, then go to the races with him every day, and help him with whatever he needs. I haven't had my first drive yet. I feel the best part of driving is the thought of getting out there, having fun and competing as hard as you can. The most challenging part is just worrying about how you are going to do and trying to make everyone happy and have those good results."

He sports a familiar familial look whenever he's in the race bike.

Fedokovitz didn't have to mull over any options when it came to his racing colors.

"I went with red and black. My initials are in red and there are red horseshoes. Those were my grandfather's colors. The only difference was that he had different initials and his don't have the horseshoes. I wanted to keep the colors as close as I could to his, but I wanted to add some of the stuff I liked on them. I want to keep those colors in the family as long as I can. I'm the first grandson, so it's almost like I'm the son he never had. I got my love of racing from my him and I also learned a lot from him too."

Fedokovitz doesn't look to any particular piece of advice he's received along the way to spur him on. Simply having the opportunity to work with the horses is motivation enough.

"I just wake up every day, go to the barn, have fun, enjoy it, and make sure everything gets done and done right. My goal is to keep the horses in the best shape possible, make sure they are healthy and ready to give their best effort every time."

Putting forth a top effort is what Fedokovitz does whenever he's called upon as a member of the Harrisville Volunteer Fire Company.

A job, like his harness racing career, than he takes great pride in.

"It definitely keeps me busy. Whenever you get a call, your heart's definitely pumping through your chest. You never know what that call is going to be and when you do get it, the adrenaline kicks in and you get yourself prepared quickly to deal with whatever comes your way. It's always something different every time, but it's always that same feeling. It gets your heart going."

Having not one, but two things in his life that he is passionate about isn't lost on Fedokovitz.

The common bond between both callings, he noted, is perhaps an obvious one.

"I think, whatever you do, you have to give everything of yourself, to make sure the job is done right and to the very best of your ability. I have to say I really enjoy doing both. With racing, I just want to learn as much as I can and become a pretty good driver. I have bunch of friends and family in the business, who have all done well, so I have some pretty big shoes to fill."

Chasing and achieving success, it seems, appears to be a perfect fit for Fedokovitz, who points to his grandfather, Johnston, Shawn Johnston and Brady Brown as all having a significant impact on his career.

"There's a lot to look forward to and I can't wait to see how everything turns out."







Party table set at Axevalla

Axevalla racetrack in Sweden plays host to a three-day party starting today (July 22) culminating on Sunday (July 24) with the \$465,000 Stochampionatet for 4-year-old trotting mares.

Twelve mares qualified for the final one week ago and the race is quite tough since the distance in both the eliminations and final is 2,640 meters (over 1.6 miles).

Offspring by Muscle Hill, Ready Cash and SJ.'s Caviar dominate the final, even if the most merited trotter ahead of the race is Djali Boko mare Lara Boko, trained by Timo Nurmos and driven by Mika Forss. Lara Boko claimed the Oaks at Solvalla in September and was the heavy favorite in her elimination last week. But she had to capitulate from the lead when upset winner Global Collection (Brillantissime) showed great speed over the stretch.

The \$465,000 Stochampionatet is unusually open this year and basically all 12 contenders can win the prestigious race.



The Italian bred Alrajah One IT earned \$1.17 million as a 13-time winner in Europe with four Group I victories that include the Italian Derby and the Gran Premio d'Europa. He has also raced in Sweden twice in the Hugo Åberg's Memorial at Jägersro and the Jubilee Cup at Solvalla, where he finished fourth. Other top-three stakes finishes came in the Gran Premio Duomo and the Lotteria, where he finished second to Face Time Bourbon last October.

Owner Scuderia My Horse Inc. shipped him to the United States in December of 2021 and he has been with the Svanstedt stable ever since. After not racing in the six months since landing in the U.S., Alrajah One IT made two qualifying starts at the Meadowlands that sort of flew under the radar. But it was his first race a week later that turned a lot of heads.

Alrajah One IT won the \$147,000 Crawford Farms Open for older male trotters by 2-1/2 lengths over Lovedbythemasses, equaling the stakes record of 1:50.4 at The Meadowlands. In that start, Alrajah One IT sat sixth to the half before following cover as his stablemate Ecurie D DK set tough fractions of :26.4, :55.2 and 1:24.4. Then coming down the lane Alrajah One IT swelled up and trotted home in :25.3 to win in 1:50.4 by 2-1/2 lengths for Dexter Dunn.

"In the Crawford, he was better than I expected, he came home so fast. Over the last three weeks he's been really good and on his schedule getting ready. I hope he has a chance to win this race because he's a horse that's going to race off a helmet. He's trained really well coming into this race," said Svanstedt.

Unlike his stablemate Alrajah One IT, Incommunicado does not hold international intrigue, but what he does have is home field advantage. Incommunicado is a Massachusetts-bred star that was the 2- and 3-year-old male trotting champion in the Massachusetts Sire Stake, going a perfect seven-for-seven in that series.

Having dual eligibility in New York, at 2 he finished third in the New York Sire Stake final. Later he went on to the Massachusetts Sire Stakes and won two eliminations and the final by 17-1/4 lengths at Plainridge Park. Then at 3, Incommunicado won the Dexter Cup at Freehold and finished third in the Empire Breeders Classic at Vernon Downs. He returned to Massachusetts in September for the Sire Stakes and ran the table again, winning three eliminations and the final by 11-1/2 lengths.

This year, he has reset his lifetime mark twice, the latest a 1:51.1, four-length romp at the Meadowlands. The following week he drew the rail in the \$432,000 Hambletonian Maturity but was interfered with by the starting gate and never got the chance to compete as a result.

Incommunicado comes into the Spirit of Massachusetts most likely in the best form of his life and knowing this surface so well, should give him a definite edge as he vies for the prize.



Harness Racing Update

"Incommunicado has won a lot at Plainridge because he likes tracks shorter than a mile. He's come on as an older horse but he will need a good trip here and if we get a check I'll be happy. There are some good horses in this race. Lovedbythemasses is a very good horse so it won't be easy to beat him. It's a very good race." said Svanstedt.

Lovedbythemasses, the second richest aged trotter of 2022, will be joined in the full field of nine by 2019 Hambletonian champion and \$1.9-million earner Forbidden Trade.

Also, former Plainridge regular and seven time 2022 winner Eurobond was a \$20,000 supplemental entry and will make his second straight start in the stake.

Other trotters entered that are very familiar with Plainridge Park are Plainridge track record holder P L Notsonice (who is also the only mare in the race), Remember Titans who is tied for second as the winningest trotter in North America (10 wins) and two-time Massachusetts Sire Stake champion Incommunicado.

The \$100,000 Clara Barton Distaff Pace was also drawn and it will be a fully loaded affair.

Defending stakes champion, Plainridge track record holder and \$2 million winner Lyons Sentinel will return to defend her title against the likes of Racine Bell, who is currently the second fastest and richest pacing mare of 2022 (behind only Test Of Faith), \$1.3 million winner Blue Diamond Eyes and \$1.1 million wonder from down under, Amazing Dream N.



Beach Glass, Pebble Beach to renew rivalry in Adios

Meadowlands Pace winner Beach Glass and North America Cup champion Pebble Beach, who have dominated harness racing's glamor division, will continue their battle for supremacy in the Delvin Miller Adios Pace for the Orchids for 3-year-old colt and gelding pacers at Hollywood Casino at The Meadows.

A pair of \$25,000 eliminations go Saturday (July 23), with the \$350,000 final set for Saturday, July 30. The eliminations card also features the Romola Hanover, a \$132,231 Pennsylvania Sire Stake for 3-year-old filly pacers, and a \$60,000 PA Stallion Series event for sophomore filly pacers. On Adios Day, the Adios final anchors a blockbuster program that features six Grand Circuit stakes.

Pebble Beach downed Beach Glass by 2-3/4 lengths in the North America Cup final to lift his lifetime bankroll to \$803.150. However, the son of Downbytheseaside—Santa Rosa has been off since then, coming to the Adios off a July 9 qualifier. He's drawn post 4, race 9 for Todd McCarthy, trainer Noel Daley and owners Patricia Stable, Joe Sbrocco, Country Club Acres and Laexpressfoderadeovolente.

Beach Glass, who goes from post 2, race 8 for Yannick Gingras, captured the Meadowlands Pace final in an impressive 1:47.2. The son of Somebeachsomewhere—Im With Her has banked \$518,750 for trainer Brent MacGrath and owners Schooner II Stable.

Trainer Tony Alagna has four Adios contenders while Ron Burke, with two, is the only other trainer with multiple entrants.

On Tuesday (July 19) Oak Grove Racing, Gaming & Hotel played host to four \$150,000 finals for 4-year-old Kentucky-bred trotters and pacers. **Blue Diamond Eyes** lowered her own track standard to 1:48.3, breaking the previous record of 1:49.1 for 4-year-old pacing mares she set in the first leg of this series on June 7. Beltassima remains undefeated this year after capturing her final for trotting mares in 1:53.4. Kildare King and Komodo Beach scored in 1:51.2 and 1:50 in their respective divisions for male pacers and trotters.

Blue Diamond Eyes and Yannick Gingras were content to settle in fourth after leaving from post position four. with Classicist (Andrew McCarthy) clicking off fractions of :25.2 and :54.2. Prior to approaching the three-quarter pole, Gingras gave the daughter of Captaintreacherous—Aria Hanover her cue. The Kentucky champion assumed control with a :26.2 quarter-mile and then paced home in :27.3. Classicist was second and Single Girl (Randy Jerrell) was third.

Trained by Ron Burke, Blue Diamond Eyes collected her fifth consecutive victory and improved her record to 40 16-7-5. The mare has now earned \$1.32 million.

Blue Diamond Eyes was bred by Brittany Farms and is owned by Thomas and Scott Dillon. She paid \$2.20 to win.

Kildare King provided Gingras with his second series final victory when he stopped the clock in 1:51.2 in the event for male trotters. In third for the first quarter-mile, Kildare King trotted to the lead at the half-mile pole and withstood the late charge of Flemsteen (Joey Putnam) to complete the exacta for trainer Chris Beaver. Jula Muscle Pack (A. McCarthy) was third.

Kildare King's record now stands at 33 10-4-3. The son of Trixton—Exclusivity has now amassed \$262,725 for owner/breeder Robert Goodman.

The gelding paid \$2.40 to win.





Trained by Robert Taylor, the daughter of Pinetucky—Beldame Hanover recorded her third win of the season from nine starts. Owned by Devon Miller, Jusmakinyalook has now amassed \$158,905 in lifetime purse earnings. Jusmakinyalook was bred by John R. Stoll. The victory was also one of three winners on the evening's program for driver Jordan Ross.

New York Sire Stake frosh fillies on hand for Batavia opener

Opening night at Batavia Downs was the scene of a crowded clubhouse, an apron full of fans and a visit from the New York Sire Stakes 2-year-old trotting fillies who competed for a total of \$105,600 in purses, divided between three \$32,500 divisions.

The first of those divisions saw **Last Page First** (Chapter Seven–Kelsy's Keepsake) take the lead and never look back.

Driver Bob McClure took control of the race before the quarter and marched his filly confidently on the point. With no challenges to speak of, Last Page First set splits of :29.3, 1:00 and 1:30 with only All The Rage (Ake Svanstedt) making a run into second. Down the lane Last Page First was on cruise and finished the deal by 3-34 lengths in 2:00.1.

It was the first lifetime win in her first lifetime start for Last Page First (\$14.40). Luc Blais trains for Determination. Tara Hills Stud and David Heffering bred the winner.

In the second split, b (Crazy Wow—Kaska) scored the upset after several breakers changed the complexion of the race.

My Belfast Angel (Tyler Buter) took the lead and the heavily favored Canterbury Hanover (Brian Sears) was positioned to claim that spot but made a break before the quarter. That left U Gurl (Marcus Miller) in the pocket and Mari (Drew Monti) drafting third. My Belfast Angel continued to lead to the half when U Gurl made a break heading towards three-quarters. When that happened, Monti pulled Mari, took the lead and never looked back. She turned for home and trotted away by 2-3/4 lengths in 2:00.

It was also the first lifetime win for Mari (\$26.20) and owner Jason Shaw. Amanda Shaw trains the winner who was bred by Annette Roydon.

Monti had the hot hand Wednesday as he also won a NYSS Excel A, Excel B and two overnights to end with five driving wins for the evening.

The third division went to **Kayleigh S** (Chapter Seven—Pasithea Face S) who won handily in gate to wire fashion.

By the time the race hit the first turn, four horses broke, leaving Kayleigh S (Brian Sears) with the lead and only Metro Matty (Drew Monti) to contend with. After setting soft fractions of :30.3 and 1:02 to the half, J Wow (Jim Marohn Jr.) and Woolco (Tyler Buter) both had caught the field and were still in the mix. Sears kept the third quarter tame again in :30.2 but let his filly loose after that. Kayleigh S opened up three lengths around the final turn and was wrapped up trotting home in a swift :29.1 to win in 2:01.3.

Kayleigh S (\$2.90) remained undefeated lifetime after scoring her second straight win for owner Courant and trainer Marcus Melander. Am Bloodstock was the breeder.

The New Sire Stakes will return to Batavia Downs on Wednesday (July 27) when the 3-year-old pacing colts and geldings will compete for a total of \$103,000 in purses.

Ervin Hanover, Annapolis Hanover PASS winners at Philadelphia

Ervin Hanover is now a double Pennsylvania Sire Stakes winner in his young career after capturing his \$81,110 division of the second prelim for 2-year-old pacing males Wednesday afternoon (July 20) at Harrah's Philadelphia, while **Annapolis Hanover** won his second straight stakes start in finishing first in the other division.

The Captaintreacherous–Eloquent Grace colt Ervin Hanover got to sit third behind Fulton, who set fractions of :27.1 and :56, and pocketed favorite Bugaboo Lou, who beat both of these colts in 1:51.3 in a Pocono Pennsylvania All-Stars race last time out. Yannick Gingras tipped Ervin Hanover out late in the backstretch to challenge the pacesetter before and after the 1:24.1 three-quarters, and the finish came down to these two after Bugaboo Hanover, with a clear inner lane after the two-hole journey, failed to fire.

Ervin Hanover managed to wear down Fulton by a neck in 1:52.1, a new lifetime mark, with Bugaboo Hanover a further 1% lengths back in third. Now the winner of two out of three purse starts, Ervin Hanover is trained by Gingras's fellow new Hall Of Famer Ron Burke for Burke Racing Stable LLC and Weaver Bruscemi LLC, J&T Silva Stables LLC, and Jim Simpson.

Annapolis Hanover (Stay Hungry–All Night Long), who was third to Fulton and Bugaboo Lou in his first PASS leg, held at The Meadows, and who won a Pocono All-Stars event in 1:51.3, needed 1:52.3 here to notch the victory for owner/trainer Mitchell York, a retired Pennsylvania state trooper. Annapolis Hanover, the favorite, sat just behind second choice Lousain Bolt in fractions of :27.4, :56.4, and 1:24.4, then showed stretch grittiness to post his fourth win in six starts, beating out first-over Stay Grounded by a neck, with first leg PASS winner Ken Hanover another three parts of a length behind in third, and Lousain Hanover fading to fourth.

Captaintreacherous dominated the siring stats in the six \$20,000 Stallion Series events, with "The Captain" the father of three winners; Sweet Lou had two successes, and Stay Hungry one.

Tim Tetrick also won three Stallion Series races – all with horses by different sires.

Two of the Tetrick wins were for trainer Jim King Jr.: the Sweet Lou–Zane Hanover colt **Lyons Stealth**, now a double Stallion Series winner and the fastest divisional winner today, 1:53 (a new mark) for Threelyonsracing; and the Captaintreacherous–Dark Secret gelding **Secret Captain**, who dropped from the Sire Stakes and broke his maiden in 1:54 for owner Jo Ann Looney-King.

Tetrick's other StS success came with the Stay Hungry–Dear Valley Miss gelding **Dempsey Hanover**, coming off an All-Stars second to here break his maiden in 1:54 for trainer Todd Luther and Black Magic Racing.

Miller, who won a Sire Stakes with a Stay Hungry, had two sons of Captaintreacherous win for him in the Stallion Series to match Tetrick with three stakes successes. The two StS winners for "The Captain" and Miller were **Quixote**, a gelding out of the dam Love Canal, who won his initial purse start in 1:54.3 for trainer Nifty Norman, co-owner with Let It Ride Cooper Stables, Bottom Line Racing LLC and Howard Taylor; and **Ship Ship Hooray**, now a double StS winner in addition to an All-Stars triumph in his brief undefeated three-race career, the colt out of Scandalous Hanover taking a new mark of 1:53.3 for trainer Chris Ryder and owners Ryder Henderson Mondillo, Ken Jacobs, and Barry Spak.

Ryder completed a StS training double with the other Sweet Lou offspring, the colt **Aperitif** (dam Candlelight Dinner), who broke his maiden in 1:53.3 for driver Dexter Dunn and Let It Ride Cooper Stables, Mac Nichol, Howard Taylor, and Bottom Line Racing LLC.




