Gural proposes stallion fee to sustain The Meadowlands until a casino arrives

The track owner said he is optimistic a casino could come to the track as early as 2027, but is proposing a new funding model to preserve racing until then.

With the 100th Hambletonian just a week away, The Meadowlands' president and chief executive officer Jeff Gural said he sees a bright future for the track, but is proposing a new plan to help raise money until he can bring a casino to The Big M.

In a release sent out yesterday (July 24), Gural said he was optimistic a casino could open at the track as early as 2027.

But before the jackpots start to pay off, Gural said he's looking for some specific support to bridge the gap.

"So, I came up with the idea of doing what the Breeders Crown people do because they don't put any money in," Gural said. "So, we're going to basically say, 'If you want to race at The Meadowlands, you have to nominate your stallion, and to nominate a stallion you have to pay half the stud fee'; only stallions standing for over \$5,000. So, most stallions have 120 shareholders, so it really doesn't cost anybody anything."

In the release, Gural said he will match 50 per cent of the revenue raised from the plan in the hopes of raising stakes purses by \$500,000 by increasing the money added to stakes by

the racetrack. There will also be no increase to stakes payments in 2026.

He told HRU that he is unsure how some of the top breeding farms will react to his proposal, since some currently aren't as supportive as others and already don't sponsor races at The Meadowlands.

"So, we'll see what they do," Gural said. "I have no idea what they're going to do."

At least one breeder that HRU knows of is on board with Gural's plan.

"Diamond Creek is fully supportive and will participate," said farm president Adam Bowden.

Among their top-notch stallions, Diamond Creek stands Meadowlands Pace champ Confederate, whose first crop, under the Gural rule, would not have been eligible to races like the Meadowlands Pace, but under Gural's new proposal the stallion's initial crop would be allowed to race at the track.

A full list of affected races is contained in the release, and just as with Gural's Stallion Restriction Condition (aka the Gural rule), the Hambletonian, Hambletonian Oaks, and E.T. Gerry Jr. Hambletonian Maturity are not on the list because those events are fully owned by the Hambletonian Society.

Races like the recently-contested Meadowlands Pace are considered stallion makers, and therefore it's perhaps logical to think that breeders would get on board with Gural's pay-to-play idea.

Part of Gural's proposal includes waiving the Gural rule for stallions that are nominated to his new plan.

"I think it comes down to, are there enough people who want to see the sport basically have a future?" Gural said. "I really think that if I can get a casino at The Meadowlands, you'll see million-dollar races. We'd be able to have a couple of those, in my opinion. And I'd have money to market the place. I really don't have the money to market The Meadowlands. I tried when we first opened, we spent money for marketing, but, if I have a casino, then that would also bring people to the place. A casino is going to be a draw in itself. I'm a horse guy that happens to be in the casino business, but the other tracks are casino people who happen to be in the harness racing business, and wish they weren't."

As for the casino, Gural said getting a state-wide referendum passed that would authorize a casino specifically at The Meadowlands is more promising than the last time it was on the ballot.

"When we had the last referendum in 2015, I was told by the

powers that be that it was written in a way that it couldn't win, and they were just doing it to shut me up," Gural said. "But it turned out to be a good thing because I learned a lot from that experience, and now, I believe I know exactly what we have to do in order to win that. And I'd be shocked if we don't get a casino at The Meadowlands to be honest with you."

Even though the referendum to allow for a casino in Northern New Jersey was soundly defeated 10 years ago, Gural said the fact that New York is set to award as many as three casino licenses in downstate New York makes this a different ballgame.

"It helps immensely," Gural said. "Let's hope Yonkers gets one. I can tell you that people will not be happy driving past The Meadowlands to go over the George Washington Bridge, sit in traffic, and pay \$18 [toll]. I'm sure that they'll look at it like this is stupid. Why can't we put one at The Meadowlands?"

Gural said among the eight applicants vying for a license, he thinks that both Aqueduct and Yonkers have an advantage because they can open quickly.

"I've spoken to the governor [Kathy Hochul], and she's made it clear that that's very important, because they need the money as quickly as possible," he said. "So, I think Aqueduct and Yonkers have a big advantage, because anybody else that's starting from scratch, it'll take them a couple of years, whereas both Aqueduct and Yonkers have publicly stated they can get open in six months.

"The other reason I'm confident [in getting a casino at The Meadowlands] is that the state [of New Jersey] needs the money desperately, and I have spoken at length to the people in the Assembly and the Senate, along with the two candidates for governor, and they've all been very supportive of the idea of putting a casino at The Meadowlands.

"The key is that the referendum has to be only at The Meadowlands, because people don't want these in their neighborhood. And that was the mistake we made last time. You could have put a casino anywhere in northern New Jersey, so that was a dumb mistake. Plus, all of the revenue that we were going to pay was going to Atlantic City, whereas in New York, [then Governor Andrew] Cuomo and I discussed it before it went on the ballot, and he correctly came up with a formula where basically everyone in the state benefited from the casino legislation.

"So, I think 80 per cent goes to education, but 5 per cent goes to the local town that it's in, 5 per cent goes to the county, and then 10 per cent goes to the surrounding counties. So, you basically had a reason for people to vote for that referendum, and it passed easily. If you look back, there was almost no opposition."

According to Gural, the sooner the New York casinos are in operation, the better the chances are for the referendum to pass in New Jersey. And unlike in 2015, he believes the opposition is not going to be in New Jersey, but from New York.

“So, you know, we’re gearing up for a fight with the New York casinos, and they’re all my friends, to be honest with you,” Gural said with a laugh. “We’ll just have to see how that plays out. I guess we’ll know in five months.”

Since horse racing on its own has not proven to be profitable, what’s to stop Gural from getting a casino and ending the racing?

“Because I think that the state wants to see harness racing,” Gural said. “They recognize that there are a lot of jobs at stake, a lot of open space; people like that. I think the politicians would insist on the harness racing.

“I think if they give me a casino, I think I can turn [the racing] around, I really do. The key is, and I’ve said it 100 times, you’ve got to have stars. You’ve got to have horses that people identify with.

“And I intend to significantly increase the purses for these major stakes, if we have a casino. Even now we’re putting in so much money compared to Yonkers or Pocono. Yonkers gets \$50 million a year from slots. Think about that.

“They get \$50 million a year, and my guess is that their contract provides that they’re allowed to use 10 per cent for stakes, because that’s typically the formula. So, Yonkers gets \$50 million, and maybe they use \$5 million for stakes, I don’t know, and we get \$7 million from the state, and use \$10 million for stakes.

“My goal is to maintain the overnight purse account, even though it’s going to cost us money, I think it’s important. And we’ve added 12 days to make up for some of the lost Freehold days. I’m a horse guy. I started going to Yonkers and Roosevelt when I was in high school. I lived 20 minutes from Roosevelt.”

Gural has shown over the years that he’s not afraid to put his money where his mouth is, dipping into his own pocket when necessary.

“It is a lot of money, but between The Meadowlands, Tioga and Vernon, I’ve probably invested \$100 million or so, and I’m not that rich, believe me, I’m no billionaire,” Gural said with a

laugh. “But I really learned a lot on Meadowlands Pace, when the people who won that race were on cloud nine. A guy was holding his grandson, who the horse was named after, and the trainer was 26 I think, and the driver is 25. We at least should try to give these people a future.

“A lot of the older people seem to have thrown up their hands and they said to me, ‘We’re a dinosaur, it’s just a matter of time,’ and I understand it, but when I was standing in the winner’s circle seeing how happy these people were, I just felt that we’ve got to give it all we’ve got.

“I hope that the industry understands that this is a two-year effort and that we want to be able to show the politicians that the industry is supporting us and not just looking for a handout.”

Facts about Hambletonian Day past and present

We're eight days out from the 100th Hambletonian and 45th Hambletonian Day in East Rutherford. Let's look at some facts/numbers that apply to this day.

1. Driver Jason Bartlet is over \$2 million up on the entire field for earnings in 2025. Never has a driver had that big of a lead and not led at year's end.
2. Only once has a New Jersey Hambletonian seen the top three favorites cross the wire in order. In 2020 the finish was Ramona Hill (2-5) followed by Ready For Moni (7-2) then Back Of The Neck (5-1).
3. 2025 marks the 13th Hambletonian Day without Mike Lachance, 11th without Ron Pierce, ninth without John Campbell, and third without Dave Brower.
4. When was the last Hambletonian where the drivers that finished 1-2 never drove in it again? In 2001 Stefan Melander won and Bill O'Donnell was second with Scarlet Knight and Pegasus Spur, respectively.
5. None of the past three Triple Crown winners were first or second choice in the Hambletonian. Windsong's Legacy (2004) was fourth choice, Glidemaster (2006) was third choice as was Marion Marauder in 2016.
6. In 2023 three straight winners came from last to first in three straight races in the three features: It's Academic in the Cashman, Heaven Hanover in the Oaks, and Tactical Approach in the Hambletonian.
7. It's been a decade since the Hambletonian winning driver was born in the USA. Brian Sears won with Pinkman in 2015.
8. Driver Braxten Boyd and Meadowlands Pace winner Madden Oaks are competing in the Cane Pace and are set for their Hambletonian Day debuts.
9. At age 36, Scott Zeron is looking for his fourth Hambletonian. In 1997, trainer Jimmy Takter was 36 when he won his first of four Hambletonians with Malabar Man.
10. It's been seven years since Manchego went 1:50 flat the fastest ever in the Oaks. The best they could manage in the Hambletonian was 1:50.1 set by Muscle Hill (2009) and Ramona Hill (2020).

11. Dave Miller aims for his 22nd Hambletonian final, having never been favored. He did have the odds-on favorite in 2005, Ken Warkentin, but failed to get to the final.
12. Bob McClure has been 1-2 in his first two Hambletonian finals. The best beginning composite in New Jersey Hambletonian driving history.
13. For the first time ever four members of the elite \$250 million driving club will be in the house on Hambletonian Day: John Campbell as head of the Hambletonian Society with Dave Miller, Tim Tetrick, and Yannick Gingras on the track.
14. Can either Tactical Landing or Nancy Takter three-peat? In 99 editions, no trainer has ever done it and no sire can claim a Hambletonian winner from his first three crops.
15. It's been 16 years since Muscle Hill won the Hambletonian en route to HOY honors. He will be in attendance on Aug. 2 at age 19. That Hambletonian was the only one called by the late, great Sam McKee.
16. Marcus Melander looks for his Hambletonian breakthrough. Remember, he had the three in the final in 2019: Greenshoe finished second, Gimpanzee was third, and Green Manalishi S fifth.
17. Wouldn't it be great if anyone attending Hambletonian Day this year showing proof they were born in 1926 got a \$100 betting voucher?

The filly foal that Jackie Gibson wasn't excited about keeps her smiling

Jackie Gibson admits she had a little bit of a tantrum when Eye Keep Smiling was born.

Gibson openly told her team at Success Stud at Young, in the rich harness heartland of the NSW Riverina, she wanted a colt with lots of white markings.

"When she was born, Robyn [McCarthy, foaling attendant] sent a photo of a colt with white markings and a plain bay filly and text 'Guess which one is yours?' Gibson said. "Of course, mine was the bay filly. I'll admit I had a bit of a sook [sulk]."

"Robyn kept that message and sent it back to me as a reminder after the mare won the Queen Elizabeth [Group 1] in May."

Fast forward almost six years and Gibson looks back and laughs.

Eye Keep Smiling, or "Louise" as Gibson calls her, has stamped herself as Australasia's best pacing mare, won 27 of her 38 starts and banked almost \$800,000.

Last Saturday night, she produced arguably *the* performance of Brisbane's Inter Dominion final night at Albion Park when she successfully defended her \$150,000 Group 1 Golden Girl crown in one of Australia's top mares' features.

In doing so, the daughter of Sweet Lou, out of Armbro Operative mare Oh Eye See, created history, becoming the first mare to break the 1:50 barrier over 1,660 meters with a 1:49.9 mile rate.

And she did it sitting parked outside the leader and main danger, Steno, all the way on a night where eight of the 10 winners raced hard against the marker pegs.

It moved her trainer/driver Luke McCarthy to tell Gibson Eye Keep Smiling was "the best mare he's driven."

Gibson said, "To hear Luke say that is exciting and humbling when you think about all the great mares he's driven. His own star Fleur De Lil, Miracle Mile winner Baby Bling and a mare I had a share in, Our Sixpence, were all absolute stars.

"The whole night was so special. Mum [Mary] came with me and we've been on cloud nine since. I think we'll just float here for a while. We actually stayed up there [Brisbane] for a few days after and that was great to soak it up.

"It Louise's 10th win in a row and in so many of them she's had to do all the hard work."

Although Gibson didn't get the colt she wanted, Eye Keep Smiling's racing style is more like a tough old gelding.

"She's not mare-ish, if you know what I mean," she said. "She's a big, strong type and races that way. She's so tough, when you think she's struggling, she always digs in like the other night."

While Gibson is the "face" of Eye Keep Smiling and Success Stud, her family business of almost 60 years, she insists it's a team effort and the whole team shares in the wonderful ride the mare is giving them.

Gibson said there was also a U.S. connection to Eye Keep Smiling.

“Her great grandmother, Jasmarella, was sold to the U.S. and finished her racing days over there,” Gibson said. “She won 50 races back in the 1980s which is some achievement.

“She won Australian 2YO and 3YO of the Year before being sold to the U.S. Later, when she popped up in a \$50,000 claimer, we bought her back and kept her going over there to make the 50 wins before bringing her back home.

“Sadly, she was a breeding disaster, but she gave us so many great moments on the track and has led to this mare.”

Through the wonder of modern equine science, Eye Keep Smiling is already a mum.

She had a foal through embryo transfer in 2023.

“It’s a Bettors Delight colt and will be sold at the Nutrien Sydney Yearling Sale on March 8 [next year],” Gibson said. “Racing them is my hobby, but breeding and selling them is our business so it’s really important.”

Despite that, Eye Keep Smiling’s latest win convinced Gibson to keep her racing for another season.

“Luke’s keen,” Gibson said. “It’s clear she’s still really enjoying her racing and going better than ever.

“We can do both, as we did back in 2023. I’ll be talking to Luke in the next few days about the best timing to flush another embryo from her. We planned to do it last year, but she didn’t

have much of a break and the timings didn’t work. I’m keen for it to work this time.”

McCarthy, who had another stellar night also winning the Group 1 Queensland Oaks aboard Soho Americano on Inter Dominion night, said he wouldn’t be afraid to take on the boys later this year and earlier next.

“She’s done it before and ran a great race [finishing fifth] in the TAB Eureka last year,” McCarthy said of Eye Keep Smiling. “She’s tough enough to do it. We’ve kept her to mares races this time and she’s thrived, but there aren’t a lot of options so we’d be willing to step outside a bit.

“I’ve got to sit down and work out a plan, but even a race like the Victoria Cup (Oct. 18) wouldn’t be out of the question if she was ready at the time. Beyond that, they’ve got the NSW Carnival of Cups up here I’d look at seriously with her.

“She’s one of those horses you just love to drive. Even when you think she’s all-out, she finds again. She’s a real winner. And it’s such a thrill sharing it all with Jackie. We’ve had a few horses together and lots of success. She’s such a big part of the game and so passionate about it.”

Carl and Jody Jamieson have a pair of talented OSS Grassroots horses

Sitting one-two in the Ontario Sires Stakes Grassroots division for 3-year-old pacing colts – as of July 25 – is the unbeaten duo of Out Of Ice and Fifth And Five.

Owned, trained, and driven by the father-and-son team of conditioner Carl Jamieson and reinsman Jody Jamieson, the sophomore tandem has taken different paths to the top, but remain equally deserving of their current position.

“They’re both very good horses, and they’re both very competitive,” said Jody, a winner of more than 8,900 races lifetime.

Both Out Of Ice, who is a perfect three-for-three against Grassroots competition, and Fifth And Five, at two-for-two, extended their undefeated stretches with landmark victories on July 15 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Out Of Ice whirled around the track in a personal best 1:49.4 for a three-length tally, while Fifth And Five achieved his lifetime mark of 1:49.2 with a 1½-length decision five races later.

“As far as Out Of Ice, he’s just becoming the nice horse that we thought he was all along,” Jody said. “It was such a huge trip the other night to come first-up in 1:49.4. He was just so impressive and I’m so proud of the horse for racing the way he is.

“ [Fifth And Five and Out Of Ice are] just good race horses and pleasant to be around. They do their job and they’re happy doing it. ”

“Then, with Fifth And Five, the trip he went the other night, he was remarkable to go 1:49.2, I mean, wow, he was huge. He’s just a little guy, but he gives everything he’s got all the time. He just needed a little break from those creatures like Crack Shot and Set Shot, and all these horses racing in the Gold. He’s got it now.”

The standout showings also left a lasting impression on their Hall of Fame trainer.

“Neither one of them were tired at the end of the mile,” said Carl, who was inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame in 2013. “They got home well, and they were happy doing it.”

While Jody and Carl have crossed paths with several first-class horses over their celebrated careers, Out Of Ice and Fifth And Five’s banner start to the OSS season has been especially meaningful considering how their individual journeys have played out.

“To be honest, Fifth And Five was probably our fourth best colt training down, and we had four pacing colts last year,” Jody said. “Now, he’s arguably a Gold horse racing in the Grassroots. We felt it was best for his development to go into the Grassroots, and not that it’s easier because we’ve been going faster than all the Golds, but by the same token he’s winning, and it’s worked out well.

“To be honest, Fifth And Five was probably our fourth best colt training down, and we had four pacing colts last year. Now, he’s arguably a Gold horse racing in the Grassroots. We felt it was best for his development to go into the Grassroots, and not that it’s easier because we’ve been going faster than all the Golds, but by the same token he’s winning, and it’s worked out well.”

“I always thought Out Of Ice might have been the best colt, but he was just a little later coming around – he had popped a curb as a 3-year-old and didn’t quite get the same opportunities as Fifth And Five and wasn’t able to capitalize on them when he did. But I always thought he was a nice horse and he’s starting to show it.”

Out Of Ice’s ascent to OSS stardom as a Jamieson homebred has made his success all the sweeter.

“Lots of times horses get sold and what have you, you bypass some horses,” Jody said. “But this guy was a homebred and he was going to be trained and raced no matter what. It’s good that he’s come and he’s the best record-wise out of that mare [Warrawee Star].”

After qualifying as a 2-year-old, the Hes Watching bay immediately entered OSS Gold competition, making six starts at the level during his rookie season.

Out Of Ice finished his maiden campaign with just over \$43,500 in the bank from one win and one second across 10 starts, two of which came in an elim and final of the Battle of Waterloo.

“He didn’t really get the trip scenarios that worked out for Fifth And Five,” Jody said. “He always tried hard, just things didn’t work out.”

The difference from age 2 to 3 is night and day.

“Things are just different this year,” Jody said. “He’s come back a little bit stronger and he’s developed a little more, but he’s always been a decent horse, and a horse that tries. It’s so hard to get horses that actually try and want to win, so when you get one, you got to try to find the right spots for them. So far, we’ve found those spots for these guys.”

Eight starts into his second professional season, Out Of Ice has already exceeded last year’s earnings mark by more than \$4,000, finding the winner’s circle in half of his outings (4-0-0).

The key to unlocking his potential? A simple adjustment, said Carl.

“As a 2-year-old, he was always on a line – you couldn’t get him off the line,” Carl said. “But as a 3-year-old this year, he’s come back and he’s driving a lot straighter now, and of course, a lot faster.”

Out Of Ice’s teammate is certainly no slouch, either.

After defying expectations in a brilliant 2-year-old campaign, one that included an OSS Gold win on Aug. 31 at Mohawk and \$173,175 in total prize money, Fifth And Five has taken yet another step in 2025.

Through eight starts, the son of Bettors Delight—Filou Fly Fast owns a strong 4-1-1 line and over \$61,000 in purse earnings.

The brown colt’s current blistering stretch of three straight Grassroots wins has set the stage for a potential return to the Gold ranks later in the season.

“We’re going to race them both in the Grassroots on Aug. 2 at Hiawatha [Horse Park],” Jody said. “I think we’ll give Fifth And Five a shot in the Gold, at least... Maybe the last two Golds.”

Elevating from the Grassroots to the Gold Series will take equal parts smart planning and good luck.

“If you go into the Grassroots final and you don’t win, then you can’t race in the Super Final,” Jody said. “I think he’s [Fifth And Five] competitive with those Gold horses, it’s just a matter of things working out for us, so it’ll depend.”

As Jody and Carl aim for their ultimate goal of capturing the Grassroots final with Out Of Ice and the Gold Super Final with Fifth And Five, they’ve each traversed enough OSS terrain to appreciate the value of staying present.

Their prized pacers make that easy.

“They’re just good race horses and pleasant to be around,” Carl said. “They do their job and they’re happy doing it.”

Chantilly is perfect through 13 career starts after easily winning OSS Gold for sophomore pacing fillies

After being scratched sick in her last two scheduled starts, **Chantilly** is back in rare form after winning the \$140,000 Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Leg 3 Gold Series event for 3-year-old pacing fillies on Tuesday (July 22) at Woodbine Mohawk Park in 1:50.2.

The overwhelming 1-9 favorite and defending Canadian Horse of the Year, is now perfect through all 13 career races for her

owner and breeder George Millar of Stouffville, ON, trainer Nick Gallucci and driver James MacDonald.

Millar was in the winner's circle and told Woodbine broadcaster John Rallis that Chantilly's sickness, "was a little bit more than we anticipated. When we scratched her from the Fan Hanover, she had inflammation in her lungs, and we just couldn't race her with that. We had a vet scope her lungs, and, especially her right one wasn't clear. We just would have done a lot of damage if we had raced her.

"Nick was hoping that he could get her clean by the following week, but just wasn't working out that way. So... you try to do what's best for the horse."

The daughter of Big Jim out of Shiraz Seelster, is now four-for-four this year and is on the cusp of \$1 million in lifetime earnings (\$985,256 to be exact). She has made \$224,256 in 2025.

Chantilly proved to be an easy winner of the six-horse field. She sat fourth in the early going as Millie May Hanover (Doug McNair), Perfectly Chic (Bob McClure) and Wickedpace (Jody Jamieson) all left the gate.

Wickedpace led the field through the :26.3 first-quarter. Shortly after, MacDonald had Chantilly out and moving. She quickly cleared, led the group through the :55.2 half and 1:24.1

three-quarters before opening up in the stretch to record a 1¼-length win over **the last Gold winner Perfectly Chic**. Millie May Hanover was third, Wicked N Single (Louis-Philippe Roy) was fourth and Wickedpace grabbed the last check.

“This filly is amazing,” MacDonald said. “It’s a pleasure to drive her. George and Nick, they’ve been great to me over the years, and it’s just great to have another great horse to drive for them... Every time I’m sitting behind her, she’s just a lot of fun. And I just can’t say enough good about her speed or her class. Everything about her is just perfect.”

Chantilly won the first Gold event of the year on May 24 in a career-best 1:49.4.

MacDonald said he was looking forward to racing Chantilly against top U.S. sophomore pacing filly Miki And Minnie and her driver Dexter Dunn before too long.

“I think Dex and I are waiting for the two giants to hook up and we just hope we’re both on our very best that day,” MacDonald said. “I know they’re going to put on a good show for the fans – they’re great horses – but I don’t think any time is out of [Chantilly’s] realm. She’s got speed like no horse I’ve, maybe, ever seen. And I just hope one day it sets up and she can put on a show for the clock, too.”

Millar said he was also looking forward to Chantilly racing against Miki And Minnie, but took objection to someone’s suggestion that Chantilly scratched out of the Fan Hanover to duck Miki And Minnie.

“I can’t really believe a person would say that,” Millar said. “Miki And Minnie is a great horse, but we got a great horse, too. That’s something about horse racing. I love the sport, and to race the best against the best, that’s what you want to see. And whatever way the cards fall, that’s the way they fall. But, you settle it on the track. Hopefully, we’ll run up against her in Pocono, there’s a stake race down there, so maybe we’ll race against her in that.”

“It’s awesome watching [Chantilly] race... She’s a thrill for me right now.”



Vic Zelenskyy, Black Velvet As sparkle at The Red Mile

On Tuesday (July 22), The Red Mile conducted two \$35,000 first round legs of the Kentucky Sire Stakes Series for older male and female trotters. **Vic Zelenskyy** returned from a vacation as a victor and **Black Velvet As** collected her second consecutive triumph in sire stakes company.

The impeccably bred Vic Zelenskyy (Greenshoe—Mission Brief) has experienced trouble staying flat throughout his career yet demonstrated his affinity for the red clay with his fifth triumph over the Lexington oval.

With Dexter Dunn at the controls for conditioner Marcus Melander, the stallion commenced trotting from post position 5 as Bargain (Marvin Luna) took control out of the gate from post position 7 through a first quarter in :28.1. Dunn, however, decided it was time to place Vic Zelenskyy in command prior to a half in :56.1. The stallion never relinquished that position through three-quarters in 1:24.2 and hit the line in 1:51. Bargain came on again with a drive in the lane, but Vic Zelenskyy was best. Mister Dad (David Miller) rounded out the trifecta.

Sent off as the favorite in the field of eight, the stallion is owned by S R F Stable as well as Holly Lane Stud East LTD. He was bred by Mission Brief Stable.

Vic Zelenskyy was a \$550,000 purchase at the 2022 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale and is the first foal out of world champion Mission Brief's five offspring of racing age to break the \$100,000 barrier after today's win.

The 4-year-old stallion's record now stands at 15 6-2-0 and he has banked \$113,510.

He last competed in the 2024 Breeders Crown elimination where he broke in the final, but he did win an elimination of last year's Kentucky Futurity.

Vic Zelenskyy paid \$5.14 to his supporters.

Black Velvet As (Dan Noble) made the best of her appearance this afternoon to score in 1:51.3, a new lifetime mark, over Justasiam As (Marvin Luna) and Danger (Robert Taylor).

The public's top choice in the field of nine, Black Velvet As left from post position 6 and settled in fourth as Butter N Syrup (Todd McCarthy, post position 7), established splits of :27.4 and :56.2. That's when Danger (Taylor, post position 5) decided it was time to go to the top and led the field through three-quarters in 1:24.1.

At that juncture, Black Velvet As was poised to strike as she had advanced into second. As Danger retreated in the drive to the finish line, Justasiam As launched her bid, but Black Velvet As proved to be the stronger of the two.

A daughter of Archangel—Provide As, Black Velvet possesses a resume of 24 7-6-2 and has amassed \$259,545.

She is trained by Anette Lorentzon, who also conditions the second-place finisher.

Black Velvet As competes as a homebred for ACL Stuteri AB. The 4-year-old entered this contest off a triumph in the \$150,000 Kentucky Sire Stakes final for this division at Oak Grove Racing, Gaming and Hotel on June 24.

The mare provided \$4.60 to all those who selected her.

Racing will continue through Sunday (Oct. 5), following a Sunday through Wednesday schedule. Fans and horsemen can look forward to 5:05 p.m. post times on Sundays, and 1:00 p.m. post times on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays throughout the meet.

Currently fourth in earnings as a sire in North America, Ready For Moni swept all three divisions of the Ohio Sires Stakes for 2-year-old colt and gelding trotters on Wednesday (July 23) at MGM Northfield Park.

Water Slide (Aaron Merriman), a \$37,000 Lexington Selected yearling purchase broke his maiden during Wednesday's first \$50,000 division in front end fashion.

Favorite Rose Run Boom (Brett Miller) and Eleven Bang Bang (Trevor Smith) were quickest into stride entering the first turn.

As they entered the backstretch Rose Run Boom took over the lead, while Eleven Bang Bang was guided back into the fourth position behind Water Slide (Ready For Moni—Above The Clouds) and Where Theres Smoke (Justin Irvine).

The lead for Rose Run Boom was short lived, however as he made a break, allowing Water Slide to inherit the lead before the :30.3 first quarter.

Water Slide maintained a 2¾ length margin through a :59.4 half with pressure coming in the form of Bitcoin King (Tyler Smith) who began a first over bid for the lead.

Bitcoin King got within a length of the lead, but at three-quarters in 1:29, Merriman asked Water Slide for more and he took off, repelling his rivals.

Through the stretch, Water Slide was confidently handled by Merriman winning by 1¼ lengths in 1:58.1. Eleven Bang Bang closed to be second, while Bitcoin King held on for third.

Owned by trainer Christopher Beaver, Michael Carter, Barry Carter and the VIP Internet Stable, the gelding pushed his career earnings to \$38,580.

Ready Russell (Dan Noble) got a ground saving trip in the second \$50,000 division, winning decisively in 1:56.4.

Max The Mighty (Merriman) left the hardest, quickly clearing rivals entering the first turn.

As the field entered the backstretch, Come N Get Me (Chris Page), who had made his way into the pocket made a break. The miscue allowed Ready Russell (Ready For Moni—Fortheloveoflindy) to grab the second spot before a :29.1 first quarter.

With the field in straight alignment, Max The Mighty kicked clear to a 1¾ length lead at the half in :59.1.

At the three-quarters in 1:28, Noble tipped Ready Russell to the outside to take his shot at Max The Mighty. The pair dueled to the top of the stretch, but Ready Russell proved to be too good, winning by 4¾ lengths.

The \$37,000 Ohio Selected yearling purchase is owned by Jeff Fought Racing, Brian Carsey and David Fought.

Trained by Deborah Swartz, the talented gelding is now undefeated in three starts and has \$56,000 in career earnings.

Special Moni (Tyler Smith) rebounded from leg one of the Ohio Sires Stakes, closing from off the pace to take the third \$50,000 division.

With a pair of breakers early, that allowed Ur Ride Is Here (Brady Brown) to be hustled off the gate, dueling with Emerald Tom (Anthony MacDonald) around the first turn.

Entering the backstretch, Ur Ride Is Here was able to clear Emerald Tom and got to the quarter in a blistering :28.4.

Brown was able to work out a :30.3 second quarter with longshot Ur Ride Is Here, but that was all the breathers he was going to get.

Special Money (Ready For Moni—Special Invitation) was sent to the outside with heavy favorite Rose Run Banker (Chris Page) on his back second over.

While the outer flow gradually advanced forward, Ur Ride Is Here proved strong on the lead getting to three-quarters in 1:28.2.

Through the stretch Ur Ride Is Here gave way and Special Moni stormed by holding off a game Rose Run Bankers in 1:58.3. Ur Ride Is Here dug in to be third.

Owned by Christopher Beaver, Spaaaartners and Tim Homan, the Chris Beaver trainee pushed his career earnings to \$25,000 with the maiden victory.

Live racing is set to resume on Saturday (July 26) featuring a 19-race Summit County Fair program that gets underway at 5:15 p.m.

Hennessey achieves 12,000th career driving win

With multiple Hall of Fame honors to his name, an illustrious career, and having recently surpassed \$80 million in career earnings, Wally Hennessey's driving resume is a highlight reel on steroids. Just when you thought there was no room left on that resume, Hennessey passed 12,000 career driving wins on Tuesday (July 22) at Saratoga Casino Hotel.

His first drive of the day was with Serge Nadeau's JK Party, trained by Eve Bergeron. The son of JK Endofanera—Street Party was heavily backed at the windows from post 5 in the field of eight going for \$8,200 in the sophomore colt and gelding pace.

Hennessey wasted little time in sending JK Party to the top, chasing the car out as they rounded the first turn. He opened up by a comfortable 2¼ lengths at the quarter in :28.2 before cruising to the half in :58.2. JK Party kept a two-length lead through the half and to the three-quarters in 1:27.2. A final quarter in :28.2 put JK Party and Hennessey in victory lane by four lengths in 1:55.4.

"I remember that feeling I had when I won my first race," said Hennessey, a Prince Edward Island native who earned most of his wins at Saratoga and Pompano Park. "I've been searching for it ever since and still haven't found it. Today was special, but it wasn't like number one."

Hennessey swept the early double to garner win number 12,001.

Trainer Andy Gardner enjoyed a hat trick on the Tuesday card.

Racing at the Spa resumes on Saturday (July 26), with a first post time of 6:45 p.m.

Lady Landia (second to Oaks-ineligible Yo Tillie in a division of the Del Miller) and What A Bid Hanover (a Del Miller division winner) are a pair of standouts for trainer Ake Svanstedt in the Oaks. Conversano, third to What A Bid Hanover in the Miller, opened the year with five wins in six starts, including victories in the Reynolds and New Jersey Sire Stakes final, and is a big-time threat from the Juan Cano barn.
