Papi Rob Hanover (David Miller) set a 1:47.1 world record while winning his Adios elimination last Saturday. On Monday, an MRI discovered he had a broken coffin bone.

But more on that in a second.

The immediate loss of Papi Rob Hanover from the racing wars is palpable. Not only is he an exquisite and talented beast of a standardbred, he was the perfect foil to the equally-talented and equally-exquisite beast called Tall Dark Stranger.

Most of us just went to grab the popcorn after the two battled like gladiators in the stretch of the Meadowlands Pace on July 18 – won by Tall Dark Stranger by a neck in a 1:47.2 mile. A week-and-a-half later, just a couple of days after Papi Rob Hanover set a stunning 1:47.1 world record for a five-eighths mile track in his Adios elimination at The Meadows, the son of Somebeachsomewhere out of Panera Hanover is on the shelf for 2020 and we are all the poorer for it in a year when we needed the distraction the most.

None, of course, are more impacted than super good guy McDuffee, Hall of Fame driver David Miller and talented trainer Brett Pelling for whom Papi Rob Hanover – along with pacing mare Caviart Ally – was a comeback horse of the highest order for Pelling's return to training in the United States.

Monday night, McDuffee said he was deeply saddened by the lost opportunity for Papi Rob Hanover to truly prove what he could do. As it stands, the colt earned just shy of \$1 million in only 16 starts – of which he hit the board every single time with a record of 7-6-3.

"His best days were, obviously, ahead of him. It's sad in that sense, for sure," the owner said.

Has there been a standardbred in recent memory with as much bad luck as talent? McDuffee doesn't think so. Consider in post draws alone this year that Papi Rob Hanover has landed, in order, 10, 10, 9 and 4.

"It's been a tough day because when I think about the

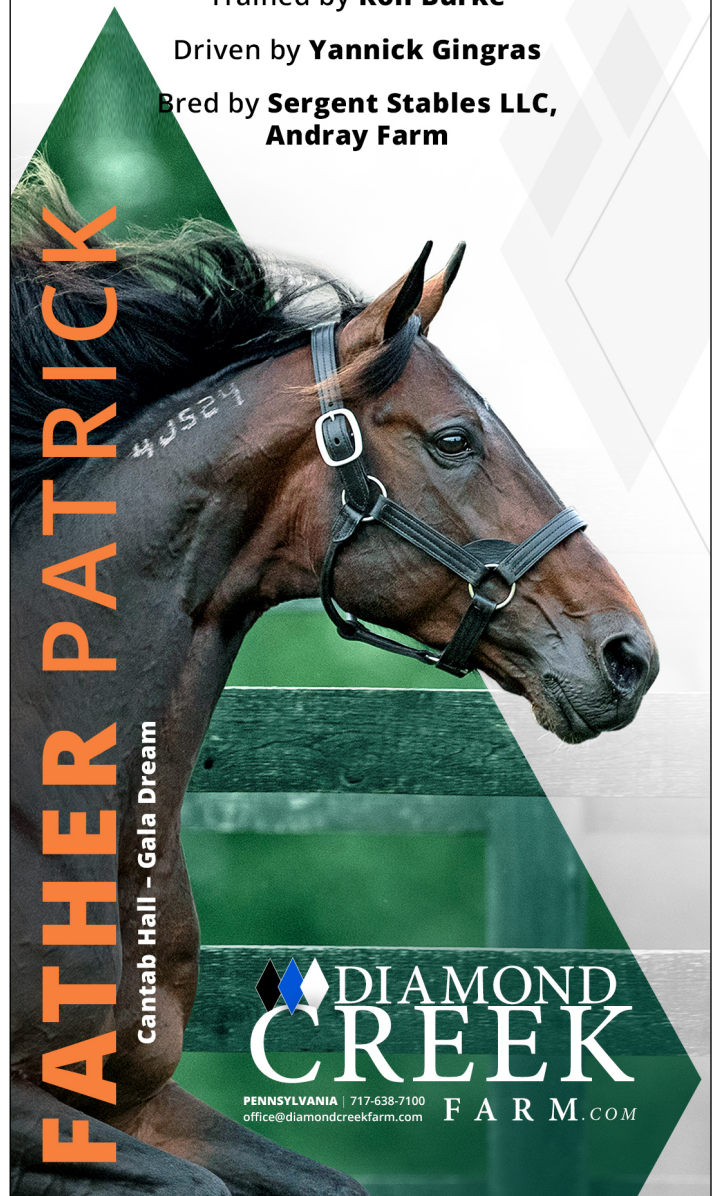

horse, I think, 'How unlucky can an animal be?' He wins the Breeders Crown and on a wishy-washy decision [the judges at Woodbine Mohawk Park] take him down. Then this year we have the virus situation. He more than likely would have won the Hempt and I'm pretty comfortable saying we would have won the North America Cup... Then we come along and we get these 10 holes every week just trying to get a race for him. Now this. Man, oh man, how unlucky can you be?"

McDuffee pauses to stress and clarify something.

"By the way, anything I say, I'm not taking anything away from Tall Dark Stranger. I think he's a special horse himself," McDuffee said.

For a man that rarely resorts to hyperbole despite a lifetime of owning many outstanding horses, what McDuffee said next is worthy of attention: "I actually believe [Papi Rob Hanover] is a better horse [than Tall Dark Stranger] and I will go to my grave believing it."

McDuffee said he will also go to his grave believing Papi Rob Hanover suffered his injury in the waning moments of the Meadowlands Pace, not the Adios elimination.

"I'm going to credit this to Brett (Pelling) whom I've talked to a lot in the last few days, but I'm pretty sure the fracture first occurred about 100 feet from the finish line in the Meadowlands Pace. If you watch that race really, really closely — and I've watched it over and over — 100 feet from the wire he was going to get the other colt and then you could see he took a little mis-step. It took David (Miller) another 20 yards to get him going and he was coming back again. I never saw him make that kind of mis-step. I'm pretty sure that's where (the injury) happened," McDuffee said, adding the team saw no signs of a problem heading into the Adios elims.

"If [he injured himself in the Meadowlands Pace] to think he went on to do what he did in the Adios [elimination] is even more spectacular, but, obviously, he's got incredible heart."

That incredible pumper is one of many characteristics that McDuffee said he hopes Papi Rob Hanover will gift to his offspring.

While it is possible Papi Rob Hanover could race next year and beyond, once he heals, McDuffee's preference is to find a good stallion home for the colt that was bred by Hanover Shoe Farms and sold to him for \$130,000 at the 2018 Standardbred Horse Sales Company's 2018 yearling auction in Harrisburg, PA.

"I think he will probably go on to be one of the best

stallions this sport has ever seen,” said McDuffee, again playing against his nature by resorting to high praise. “He’s just an incredible animal and I would actually prefer to go that route than bring him back next year. I think he’s destined to become a great stallion and I say it because physically he’s the most impressive thing you ever looked at – he’s got conformation, he’s a smart horse – some horses are gifted, but they’re not too bright – he’s got everything going, including pedigree. My preference is to find a good home for him and more than likely I will.”

Naturally, the breeding farms had been calling before an MRI on Monday revealed the broken coffin bone. There’s every belief Papi Rob Hanover will land a great spot for his second career once the final decision is made to go that route.

McDuffee, for one, is counting on it while remaining philosophical.

“One thing I’ve learned in this business is that every single race is maybe your last one,” McDuffee said. “You just don’t know. These are animals carrying 1,500 pounds plus on those little legs that they have to pound on the ground. You’re only one race away with any horse. This one is a tough one to digest, but we’ll live for another day.”

Back Of The Neck, Ready For Moni top Hambletonian eliminations

With each having recorded a sharp score in their respective divisions of the Stanley Dancer Memorial, **Back Of The Neck** and **Ready For Moni** have been installed as the morning-line favorites in their respective Hambletonian eliminations, which take place Saturday (Aug. 1) night at The Meadowlands. The \$1 million Hambletonian Final is Aug. 8.

In the first of two \$50,000 elims, Back Of The Neck is listed at 2-1 from post one for driver Scott Zeron and trainer Ake Svanstedt. After missing a nose in his seasonal debut on June 27 to Sorella – one of The Hambletonian Oaks favorites – the son of Ready Cash—Big Barb has reeled off two straight wins from off the pace in impressive fashion, scoring in the July 11 Reynolds in a lifetime-best 1:52 before his Dancer win on July 18, also in 1:52.

“No, he is not one dimensional,” said Zeron after being asked if his horses’ best game is coming from behind. “His best effort was on the front end in his first start. To have come home in :26.1 and get picked off at the last second, that was a great effort.



“I avoided the front end going forward because I wanted to teach him to do other things. [Having drawn post 1] Gives me options. I definitely don’t have one trip in mind. I avoided the front in his last two on purpose, but we will play it by ear. I’m happy with the post position.”

Ready For Moni will start at 5-2 on the big board from post 8 in the second elim as Nancy Takter and Yannick Gingras look to become the first trainer-driver team to sweep The Meadowlands Pace and The Hambletonian in the same year.

The son of Ready Cash—Nothing But Moni went a perfect cover trip in his only outing of 2020 when he won his Dancer split in a lifetime-best 1:51.4 after kicking home in :27.1.

So, what about the outside post position?

“I’m a little indifferent about it,” said Takter. “On paper, it looks like we are in the easier of the two eliminations. I think we are in good shape. I think the eight is a good spot.”

Takter is not concerned about Ready For Moni having only had one outing this season.

“It’s just the way his schedule played out,” said Takter. “I would have preferred one or two more starts but all of our horses have a good foundation. I think it’s a myth that these horses need a lot of races. They go so fast. I think [having too few starts] is better than having too many.”

FABULOUS FILLIES: Attempting to become the next filly to win the Hambletonian (Atlanta was the last in 2018) are Ramona Hill (5-1 in the first elim) and Sister Sledge (3-1 in elim two).

OAKS A SINGULAR EVENT: The \$600,000 Hambletonian Oaks saw 12 horses enter, meaning that event for 3-year-old fillies on the trot will not need eliminations and will be one dash for the cash on Saturday, Aug. 8.

POST DRAWS LIVE: The post-position draws for both The Hambletonian and Hambletonian Oaks will take place during Saturday night’s program at The Meadowlands and will be broadcast on the track’s in-house simulcast feed live.

Catch The Fire, The Greek Freak grab early Adios spotlight

With presumptive favorite Papi Rob Hanover injured and out of Saturday's \$375,000 final at The Meadows, the race has opened up considerably.

When **Papi Rob Hanover** blazed to a world-record 1:47.1 in last week's eliminations for the Delvin Miller Adios Pace for the Orchids, the harness racing world eagerly anticipated what he might do for an encore in the \$375,000 Adios final on June 1. Alas, it won't happen, as Papi Rob Hanover has been withdrawn from the final with what his owner, David McDuffee, describes as a stress fracture of his left front coffin bone as first reported by HRU ([full story here](#)) and further detailed in today's lead story.

With Papi Rob out, attention turned to **Catch The Fire** and **The Greek Freak**, the other elimination winners, who got to select their post positions. The connections of Catch The Fire, after winning the draw for selection order, choose post 3, while The Greek Freak's camp opted for post 4. Papi Rob Hanover's withdrawal opened a spot for **Captain Barbossa**, who drew in as the fourth place finisher with the highest career earnings.

The Adios, which goes as race 15 with an approximate post time of 4:02 p.m. ET, anchors a powerhouse card that also features the \$107,320 Quinton Patterson Adios Volo for

3-year-old filly pacers, a \$59,088 Arden Downs stake for freshman colt and gelding pacers, and a \$35,690 Arden Downs event for 2-year-old filly pacers. Other highlights include a pair of stakes for 3-year-old filly trotters: a \$187,182 Pennsylvania Sires Stake and an \$80,000 PA Stallion Series event. The card gets underway at the special post time of 11:25 AM.

McDuffee said Papi Rob Hanover, a son of Somebeachsomewhere-Panera Hanover nearing \$1 million in earnings after only 16 career starts, including a second-place finish in the Meadowlands Pace, won't race again this year.

"I don't think his injury happened at The Meadows," he said. "I believe it occurred in the Meadowlands Pace when he hopped for a moment and David (Miller) had to take hold of him. If he'd shown any signs of injury, we wouldn't have raced him at The Meadows. You saw how easily he won his elimination."

He said he won't make a hurried decision on the horse's future.

"It's not a life-threatening injury; it will heal in time," he said. "There could be a lot of records he could set at 4. Stallion-wise, he's also generating a lot of interest. He's a very special, smart horse. Papi Rob will be heard from again."

Trainers Tony Alagna and Ron Burke each will be represented by three horses in the Adios. Here's the field with post positions, trainers and drivers:

It didn't take long for Sarah Andrews to discover factory work was not for her

Four days of work, three days off. The job seemed full of promise, but for Sarah Andrews, it was missing one key element.

In many ways, the decision to leave the harness racing world to work in a completely different industry was an expedition of sorts.

If working in the manufacturing plant turned out to be rewarding – not just in the monetary sense – Andrews would consider making a career of it.

And if it didn't pan out, she could always go back to standardbred racing.

Andrews figured out the answer in a relatively short period of time.

"I worked for [trainer] John Butenschoen for a while, and a big company moved into the area," said Andrews. "I thought it would be a good idea to get a traditional-type job. I worked four 12-hour shifts and then I would have three days off. Then, you worked three 12-hour shifts and had four days off. It sounded good at the time. But I didn't like the 3 a.m. to 3 p.m. shifts. It just didn't work out. Punching the clock and having to be there in that environment... it wasn't the same as being around the horses. I missed them."

Horses were on her mind the moment she accepted the job.

So much so, in fact, that on her days off, Andrews didn't turn her alarm clock off to get some much-needed rest. She had somewhere to be.

"I still went and helped John on some of my days off because I missed it. It didn't take me long to realize where I wanted to be, so I quit the job in the plant and came back to the horses. I actually came back to work for John."

Andrews had first met Butenschoen when she was 16. A family friend took her to his farm in Marengo, IL, not far from where Andrews lived.

The visit proved to be the launching pad for a life in horse racing.

For over 20 years, Andrews worked as an assistant trainer for a number of standardbred stables, including some of the most successful ones in the sport.

After working for Butenschoen, she moved to the New Jersey operation of Carl Porcelli, Jr. before beginning her association with trainer Joe Holloway.

With Holloway, she found herself around some of the game's biggest stars, including Always B Miki and Breeders Crown champion Divine Caroline.

What she learned from all of her experiences was akin to an Ivy League education.

It also helped her graduate to the ranks of full-time trainer.

While she had conditioned horses of her own over the years, it was in 2017 when she truly began to make her mark.

In 2017, in just her second campaign at The Meadows, Andrews recorded 34 wins accompanied by a .253 UTRS.

"A couple of years ago, I had a friend send me some horses for a couple of different owners, just because they couldn't get them in, and it started snowballing from there. I ended up keeping those owners to this very day. [Trainer] Scott De Domenico, he's always helped me out, sending horses out here in Pennsylvania that he needed to get raced."

One of those horses was Normandy Beach, a bay son of the legendary Somebeachsomewhere.

In 2018, under Andrews' tutelage – eight starts in all – Normandy Beach won four times, including three consecutive races.

"Just a really nice horse. He's a Pennsylvania-bred and Scott thought he could do well because he fit some classes out here. It worked out really well. [Owner] Adam Friedland, and [owner, former driver/trainer] Brian Carsey started giving me horses on top of Normandy Beach – it was Scott who sent the horse to me – but it really snowballed from there. Brian, and other owners, they started to send me horses pretty much because of that horse."

Andrews has certainly capitalized on the opportunities she's been given.

After a 55-win season in 2018, she won a career-best 66 races last year.

"I've just been lucky getting the right horses fitting out

here – that’s the hardest part. The classes out here are sometimes tricky in trying to find the right horse for the right class. But we’ve had good luck getting the right ones sent out here.”

Good fortune is far from the only reason for Andrews’ success.

Her willingness to listen and learn over the years has helped her shape a training style of her own, a philosophy that contains useful pointers she’s picked up from others along the way.

“I’ve worked for a lot of different trainers and I still use a lot of what they’ve done and incorporate that into my own program. It’s worked out well. For me, the one thing that’s always stayed with me is that you don’t keep a horse in your barn if it’s not doing well at the racetrack you’re at. You need to be honest with the owners. You just tell them, ‘Maybe it’s better if someone else tries with the horse.’ The owners appreciate that.”

It’s obvious they do.

Andrews, who currently has 12 horses in her barn, is grateful for the support.

“At one point, it was a challenge to find owners that would

keep horses in your barn – you get a horse and then they move on. It was so up-and-down for a while. It was hard for a long time and at certain points, I’d have to go back and work for other people. Now, it’s really good. I feel very fortunate.”

Which is how she feels about the return of live racing after the COVID-19 pandemic shut down live racing across North America.

“It was tough. When we got the word we could race again, I knew my horses would be thoroughly ready because we made sure they were in great shape. I was just so happy to be back. I was thrilled. When you didn’t have anything to look forward to it was tough. You always look forward to the next day when your horse is in to go.”

Although there’s no need to ask Andrews if she’d ever consider a job outside of harness racing, she’s happy to provide an answer.

“No way. After that job at the manufacturing plant, I knew that this was going to be what I wanted to do. I gave it a try, but it just wasn’t for me. This job... it definitely is.”

Manchego sets 1:49.3 world record in Spirit of Massachusetts Trot

Shartin N shatters all-time track record in the Barton.

Manchego put on a display of devastating speed in a gate to wire victory in the \$250,000 Spirit of Massachusetts Trot at Plainridge Park on Sunday (July 26) and set a new world record for aged trotting mares over a 5/8th's mile track when she tripped the timer in 1:49.3.

Manchego broke her own world record of 1:50.1 set at Hollywood Dayton Raceway in 2019. The time also smashed the all-age track trotting record at Plainridge Park, besting the 1:51.2 set by JL Cruze in the 2017 Spirit Trot.

Dexter Dunn had Manchego revved up off the gate and shot right for the lead with Atlanta (Yannick Gingras) dropping in the pocket from post seven as the race passed the quarter in a blistering :25.2. The field remained in single file as Manchego marched to the half in :53.3 and the three-quarters in 1:21 with Atlanta in deliberate pursuit.

As the pair trotted away from the field around the last turn, Gingras pulled Atlanta off the pylons to take her best shot at the leader. But as soon as she pulled, Manchego accelerated, opened up two lengths and proceeded to the wire under no urging at all to win wrapped-up by 2-1/2 lengths.

Atlanta held on for second and Run Director (David Miller) closed fast to finish third.

It was the 31st career win for Manchego (\$3.00) and it pushed her lifetime earnings to over \$2,342,705. The 5-year-old daughter of Muscle Hill—Secret Magic is owned by Black Horse Racing and is trained by Nancy Takter.

One race earlier in the \$100,000 Clara Barton Distaff Pace, **Shartin N** made herself right at home again at Plainridge as she broke the all-age track record that she set here just last year.

Tim Tetrick put Shartin N on the point immediately as Kissin In The Sand (Yannick Gingras) left from post four and followed closely with the two-hole trip. After the quick :26.2 quarter and with no pressure at all, Tetrick backed down the second panel to :28.1 and the race seemed well in control for him at that point.

By the five-eighths, Gingras pulled Kissin In The Sand and tried to draw alongside Shartin N, but never got closer than a length around the far turn. Tetrick eased the lines a bit and gave Shartin N her head and the mare swelled up down the lane, opening up 2-1/4 lengths in a :27 flat last panel and won in 1:48.1.

Stablemate Soho Burning Love A (Jordan Stratton) rallied late to finish second and 38-1 shot Philly Hanover (Dexter Dunn) completed the board.

Shartin N (Tim Tetrick) won the \$100,000 Clara Barton Distaff Pace and broke the all-age track record with a 1:49.1 mile that broke the record she set at Plainridge in 2019.

The time was a new all-age track record at Plainridge Park which was set last year in this same stake by Shartin N when she cruised home in 1:49.1, and it was only one-fifth of a second off the world record of 1:48 for an aged pacing mare over a five-eighths mile track that is co-held by her and Somwhorvarainbow.

This was the 44th career victory for Shartin N (\$2.60) who has now earned \$2,244,946 for owners Richard Poillucci, Jo Ann Looney-King and Tim Tetrick. The 7-year-old daughter of Tintin In America-Bagdarin is trained by Jim King Jr.

Battle fields set for Industry Day at Grand River Raceway

Finalists were decided Monday night (July 27) for Grand River Raceway's two feature pacing races highlighting the track's 30th Industry Day event on Aug. 3.

Canadian season records (for rookie pacers over a half-mile track) were set in the first of two divisions for the Battle Of Waterloo and in both divisions for the Battle Of The Belles.

BATTLE OF WATERLOO ELIMS

Bettor Sun and Doug McNair left from post five to capture the lead in the first elimination dash (Race 3) and was overtaken by the 1-9 favorite Springbridge Duel with Bob McClure by the half-mile marker. But Bettor Sun, a longshot whopper at 35-1, managed to eclipse the pair in the stretch with a maiden-breaking charge in 1:54.1 for breeder/owner Willow Oak Ranch. Gregg McNair trains the Sunshine Beach colt.

Springbridge Duel was the runner-up by a length. Trained by Casie Coleman Herlihy, the son of Big Jim was a \$40,000 yearling acquisition for West Wins Stable, Steve Heimbecker and Mark Kantrowitz.

Socrates Blue Chip was third with Jody Jamieson and Armor Seelster with Louis Philippe Roy rounded out the top four.

Candy Trader scored his second straight win for trainer Anthony Beaton in the second elimination division (Race 6). In rein to Sylvain Filion, the pacer popped out from the rail to rush by stretch leader Avion Seelster (Jody Jamieson), winning by a neck in 1:55.2. Beaton conditions the Bettors Delight gelding for Steve Heimbecker, Larry Menary, Michael Guerriero and Ben Murdy. The partners paid \$72,000 for Candy Trader as a yearling.

Candy Trader drew post seven for next week's final, but Beaton wasn't fussing about it.

"The outside may be a good spot for him," he said. "He likes a helmet to follow."

The pacer is Beaton's first-ever starter in the Battle Of Waterloo. (He also has a pair of fillies advancing to the Battle

Of The Belles.)

"He's done everything right so far. I think we'll be hearing more from him this season."

The division's runner-up, Avion Seelster is owned and trained by Jack Darling. The Sportswriter son was an \$80,000 yearling purchase and a winner in his first career start at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Cantstoplying was third with Louis Philippe Roy for Nick Gallucci. No Bettor Joy rounded out the top four finishers with Bob McClure for Nicky Comegna.

One mare contested the \$350,000 Hugo Åbergs Memorial Tuesday night (July 28) and she won against some of the best trotters Europe can offer at this moment. **Double Exposure** (Donato Hanover), played with the boys in a 1:51.2 mile.

Örjan Kihlström had his tactics in mind from the start. Behind Double Exposure from a great post, there were not many options other than aiming for the lead. In front, Double Exposure simply left her opponents with 300 meters to go and the victory was outstanding.

Cokstile finished second after a pocket trip while Tae Kwon Deo held strongly in a fast finish from position first over.

Four-year-old Ecurie D. was the bettor's first choice in the race, but the Frode Hamre-trained Infinitif son could never challenge the top trio from fourth over. Driver Erik Adielsson said the race, for their part, was decided when the draw was made. Ecurie D. started from post 10, a tough assignment for any horse, especially for a 4-year-old who was tackling the elite for the first time.

Daniel Redén trains the winner Double Exposure. His pupil Propulsion won Hugo Åbergs Memorial three years in a row (2016-2018), but the son of Muscle Hill is under investigation due to a nerve procedure made in America before he was bought to Sweden and Propulsion might lose all his victories. So when another American bred trotter, a mare in this case, won the prestigious mile race, Redén became emotional.

"How can it be possible that a mare makes this performance? It feels so... special and we've been here and won the race three times before and now...yes...yes, I can't speak right now," said Redén with tears in his eyes.

Home favorite all the way in Breeders Course final

Jägersro trainer Per Nordström celebrated a victory in the \$160,000 Breeders Course 3 years old 2020 Second final as he steered his Chocolatier son **Önas Prince** to a safe wire-to-wire win in 1:54.4, which is a new track record for 3-year-olds at Jägersro.

Önas Prince owns one attribute that is valuable in mile races on five-eighths mile tracks and that is the ability to leave quickly behind the gate, a weapon that Per Nordström used correctly on Tuesday night.

Dutch owned Kuyt F.Boko finished strongly as second, five lengths behind the winner while Italian trotter Boltigeur Erre held to third place.

Vivid Wise As a winner again

Alessandro Gocciadoro-trained **Vivid Wise As** (Yankee Glide) took over the lead after a quarter of a mile when the \$205,000 Gran Premio Freccia d'Europa was held in Naples, Italy, on Sunday night (July 26).

When in front, Vivid Wise As played with his opponents and Alessandro Gocciadoro has done a nice

job putting his trotter in such a great shape during the summer. Vivid Wise As was sent to Björn Goop's stable in Sweden ahead of the Elitloppet, a race in which Vivid Wise As was the bettor's first choice just a week before the show.

Then, in May, Vivid Wise As didn't perform at his best, but since he came back to Gocciadoro's stable in Italy, the son of Yankee Glide has taken big steps towards the very best trotters in Europe again.

Vivid Wise As came home in 1:53.2 and he had more to give, if it would have been necessary.

Barbaresco Grif (Conway Hall), trained by Holger Ehlert in Italy, won \$237,000 Gran Premio Citta di Napoli paired with driver Enrico Bellei in mile rate 1:57.1 over 1.3 miles on the same night in Naples.

Jim Frick dies

Swedish trainer and driver Jim Frick (born in 1951) has died at the age of 68. was involved in an accident in March of 2010 and had to quit his active career in harness racing industry. Until then, Jim Frick had achieved over 5,000 victories in the sulky and over 3,000 as a trainer and maintained a big profile in the sport.

Frick's ability to drive all sorts of trotters made him a very respectable and popular driver in Sweden and he became the winningest driver in his home country four times (1978: 165 victories, 1979: 184, 1985: 185 and 1986: 199).

In 1987, Frick won the title European Drivers Champion and he's the only Swedish driver that has achieved that.

Earlier this summer, Frick entered the exclusive Hall Of Fame in Sweden and in 2012 he was designated as Ambassador of honor in Swedish harness racing.

About a year ago, Jim Frick suffered from prostate cancer and on Saturday night (July 25) he died.

Swedish harness racing grieves the loss of a big artist, a gentleman who saw people, spoke to people and liked to be around people all around the tracks.

Jim Frick will be missed by the world of harness racing.

Canada's youngest race caller is tracking down a dream

Eighteen-year-old Nathan Bain becomes the announcer at Leamington Raceway.

It's official – Nathan Bain is Canada's newest, and youngest, track announcer. On Aug. 9 he will be on the mic at his hometown Leamington Raceway to start the 2020 season. "The position became available this year. Last year, [Gary Patterson] from Dresden Raceway filled in," said the recent high school graduate. "I'm 18. I'm ready. I have 100 calls at nine different tracks, six in Canada and three in the US."

Leamington Raceway has grown up alongside its increasingly well-known ambassador, rapidly evolving from a small fair track to Windsor Raceway's closest geographical successor in southern Ontario. Bain said he visited the latter "as a kid, but I didn't like it and I wanted to go home."

Leamington relaunched as a pari-mutuel venue in 2013, after Windsor Raceway permanently closed.

"When [Leamington] reopened, I was 11 and I was there on opening day, to support my grandfather's horses," said the long-time racing fan. "There used to be four days of fair racing, before they got 13 race days." The half-mile, non-slots racing venue is operated by the not-for-profit Lakeshore Horse Racing Association, which is looking to renew its pari-mutuel racing contract after the current five-year deal with the province expires later this year.

Although COVID-19 precautions will keep Leamington Raceway from opening its historic grandstand to fans this season, Bain said horsepeople will find the paddock well-equipped to manage social distancing measures. "Some of the owners like to come in the paddock and are not allowed to anymore. Essentially, it's one groom [per horse] and the trainer," Bain said. "We're lucky we just built a nice paddock five years ago, and it's for like four or five races, pretty spread out, so that works out really well." With large sliding doors for ventilation on each row, the structure can safely accommodate the essential workers attending to horses there.

The Windsor-Essex County racetrack must follow provincial

guidelines specific to its location, regardless of what other Ontario tracks are doing, because the local agri-farm industry (but not its racing colony) and long-term care homes have been hit hard by COVID-19. "The Leamington area remains in Stage 2, probably for a while," said Bain. "We can't have anyone here until we're in Stage 3. We have no choice."

He said he's disappointed for the fans and bettors who normally populate the ancient grandstand's ground-level bar and outdoor seating areas, the die-hards often toting their own lawn chairs. Many are former Windsor Raceway or Michigan horseplayers. "They out-bet some of the other Ontario 'B' tracks here," said Bain, who hopes that a new graphics package this season will contribute to a stronger online presence and greater appeal to the American ADW audience. Last year, the single-card handle averaged \$34,000 (Cdn), with around \$27,000-\$28,000 of that total wagered on track.

"I'm anxious what the handle is going to look like this year," said Bain. "We're open to a lot of ideas this year."

Expect contests, more online content, and even a

newly-installed camera in the race-caller's booth, allowing Bain to present handicapping notes and program changes with the same visibility (and camera) that Clinton Raceway guest callers Frank Salive and Greg Blanchard have been using this summer.

Bain earned his announcing position thanks to years of rehearsals, which began with recording his race calls on a phone app at home and bringing them to Leamington Raceway for in-house critique. "I'd get the program early and just practice and practice. I definitely pushed a lot to get opportunities," he said. Although Nathan's family owns six standardbreds, including the currently-active Onimpulse and Smile In Style, and his grandfather, horseman Tom Bain, is current Mayor of Lakeshore and past Warden of Essex County, these factors didn't make his rise to the booth inevitable. Instead, Nathan sought out chances to guest-call at various venues, starting with a single race at his home track's Kids' Day in October, 2014. He readily recalled that it was won by trotter Coffee Black, driven by Scott Wray.

"For 2015 and 2016, I did the [Leamington] Kids' Days. I was only doing one race per card at that point," said Bain. "Flamboro reached out to me in 2017, so I called a couple of races there." Encouraged by announcer Gary Guy, Nathan went to Grand River Raceway to call a single race in August 2017, and returned to Flamboro for a couple more in 2018. "I called my first race in London [The Raceway at Western Fair] in January 2018. I would go up and sometimes announce the post parades there, starting in 2015. [Announcer] Sugar Doyle would give me advice."

In 2018, Bain asked Dresden Raceway's general manager Greg Blanchard about opportunities. "We talked about my joining the team, and I got hired to do picks for the program, interviews and that," said the aspiring race caller. "I was back-up announcer and created a Twitter account for them, too." Although unable to participate in the same way this summer at Dresden, Bain stayed involved thanks to the track's race caller.

"Gary Patterson is really good there. He connected me to Gerald Hill from OnTrack [Media and Entertainment], and gave me the graphics operator position at Dresden," he told HRU. "Now I work up on top in the OnTrack room where the camera person is. We're both wearing masks."

The two tracks' dates intersect perfectly for Bain, with the Dresden meet ending Aug. 3, one week before Leamington's August 9 season opener. Although Leamington Raceway's Sunday race dates would not have interfered with his upcoming academic year in St. Clair College's Advertising

and Marketing Communications Management program, the newly-named announcer won't be travelling to classes at the Windsor campus, anyway. "Everything is going to be online this year. There are pros and cons," he said.

With his dad, Dave, getting his trainer's license this week, Nathan said he also plans to be in the industry for years to come. He shared updates on six family-owned standardbreds, including a pair of 2-year-olds (Up the Credit filly Recall Tootsie and Armbr Warranty gelding Spare Time Serg) who are turned out; 3-year-old Warrawee Needy filly Tilly Dreamcatcher who is "just starting to come back"; and race mare On a Cloud, who is "out in the field" after failing to get in foal.

There have been disappointments, but Nathan Bain's interest and involvement in racing have stayed strong. "I was supposed to call a race at Pompano this year, but then they cancelled," he said, recalling how his family vacation was suddenly on indefinite hold in March due to the emerging pandemic. "Actually, we cancelled before they cancelled – we were supposed to go on a cruise. We're happy we stayed home."

Bain had previously called individual races at Northfield Park and Miami Valley Gaming, and was looking forward to his return to Isle Casino at Pompano Park, the scene of his most unforgettable night at the track. During March Break 2017, Nathan met announcer Gabe Prewitt and Goshen Hall of Fame Communicator John Berry at Pompano, then called a race there: "It was a lot of pressure. Frank Salive came in right before, and then John Campbell came in." Afterwards, the Bains were joined by the Hambletonian Society's Campbell, Moira Fanning, and Tom Charters to watch the remaining races together.

Follow Nathan and Leamington Raceway at lakeshorehorseraceway.com when the live racing season gets rolling Aug. 9. The track will play host to the Prospect Series for 2-year-old pacing fillies as part of its season-opener card; 2-year-old and 3-year-old male pacers Sept. 6; and 2-year-old male trotters Sept. 13. Leamington is also racing on Labour Day 2020 (Monday, Sept. 7) in exchange for giving up its Aug. 2 race date to Dresden.

Potential source of positive tests for capsaicin

On July 20, 2020, the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) issued a Notice to Industry concerning a number of horses in Ontario who have received a positive test for capsaicin over the past several weeks. As noted, the AGCO's priority is to conduct a fair and independent investigation to ensure the ongoing safety and integrity of horse racing in Ontario, as well as the health and welfare of equine athletes.

The AGCO Equine Drug Unit's preliminary investigation has revealed a potential source: a product known as **ZEV** (Lot#190104 Exp:01-2022) — an oral product used for the treatment of respiratory conditions — has tested positive for capsaicin and related compounds. It should be noted that capsaicin is not included in the list of active ingredients for **ZEV**.

Trainers and owners are advised to always use caution with all products administered to a horse. Not all ingredients which could result in positive tests may be listed on a product, and **ZEV** may not be the only source of a positive test.

McWicked standing Southern Hemisphere season at Cobbitty Equine Farm

McWicked (p,2,1:52f; 3,1:47.3f,1:46.2 \$5,103,271), the 2018 Horse of the Year and the richest pacing stallion in harness racing history, will stand his initial Southern Hemisphere season at the renowned horse haven Cobbitty Equine Farm.

Already established as a farm that delivers world class facilities for all aspects of horse racing, Cobbitty Equine have extended their stallion roster to cater for the commercial breeder and the yearling sales market.

McWicked will stand his introductory year at exceptional value at \$5,500 including GST with a live foal guarantee (multiple mare discounts apply).

Grit, determination and raw talent propelled McWicked through a seven-year racing career that saw him earn over \$5 million dollars, with 40 appearances in the winner's circle and a record of 1:46.2 over the Red Mile. With those statistics, the son of McArdle—Western Sahara joins an elite group of horses elected into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame just months after his last appearance on a racetrack.

He retires as the richest pacing stallion ever and is second behind Foiled Again on the all-time earnings list for pacers.

In 2018, he was the oldest horse in 43 years to top the leading money earners list in North America.

At 2, McWicked won two Pennsylvania Sire Stakes divisions and prize money of \$179,617. He dominated his rivals as a 3-year-old winning the Breeders Crown, Delvin Miller Adios Stakes Final, Max Hempt Memorial elimination and final, North America Cup elimination, Progress Pace Preview and two Pennsylvania Sire Stakes and final.

In 2014, McWicked was both the USHWA and O'Brien Award winner for 3-Year-Old Colt Pacer of the Year.

At 4, McWicked was second in the Allerage Farm Stakes. From 5 to 8, McWicked won the Allerage Farms twice, Ben Franklin elimination and final, Breeders Crown final, Canadian Pacing Derby final, Dan Rooney Invitational division twice, George Morton Levy Series leg, Jim Ewart Memorial twice, Joe Gerrity Jr. Memorial division, Mohawk Gold Cup, TVG Open final, and William R. Haughton Memorial division.

He took a mark of 1:46.2 winning the 2018 Allerage at Lexington's Red Mile, which is the third-fastest winning race mile in history. McWicked achieved this record in one of his many Northern Hemisphere tussles with the "Wonder from Down Under" Lazarus.

The two-time Breeders Crown winner is known not only for his amazing speed, but his toughness, soundness and conformation.

"McWicked gave it 110 per cent every time he got behind the gate," said trainer Casie Coleman. Rookie pacing colts and geldings were on display Monday evening (July 27) at Woodbine Mohawk Park for the first leg of the Dream Maker Series.

The Dream Maker Series has annually been a launching pad to stardom for some of the sport's top pacing colts and geldings. Last year's series was an early season stop for several of this year's top 3-year-old pacers, including series-winner Capt Midnight and preliminary leg winners Allywag Hanover and Tall Dark Stranger (did not race in the final).

Betting Line colt **Dean B Hanover** took Monday's first division impressively in 1:52.1. The Casie Coleman-Herlihy trainee and driver Travis Cullen shot out to the early lead and let stablemate Beachhead overtake the top spot racing to the half, before powering by in the lane with a :26.3 final-quarter for a 2 ³/₄ length win.

Beachhead just held on for second over Ucanttouchthis, while Somewhereinverona was fourth.

Dean B Hanover is now two for two in his young career and does have plenty of expectations to live up to after being

purchased for \$340,000 as a yearling at Harrisburg. He is owned by Mac Nichol, John Liviakis and Blue Chip Bloodstock Inc.

A \$2 win ticket on Dean B Hanover returned \$5.70.

Island Beach Boy capitalized on a miscue by 1-5 favorite Linedrive Hanover to win the second division in 1:52.1.

The early portion of the race saw Perfectboy Hanover cut an opening-quarter of :28. Keystone Catalyst looped to the top from second, but his lead was brief as Linedrive Hanover rushed third to first through a half of :56.

Linedrive Hanover paced a strong third-quarter of :27.3 to lead into the lane, but early in the stretch started to put in some awkward steps and made a break.

Island Beach Boy sat back fourth throughout and unleashed a good :27.3 final-quarter for driver Sylvain Filion to sweep by rivals and capture win by 2 ¹/₂ lengths. Keystone Catalyst finished second, while Perfectboy Hanover was third. Linedrive Hanover reset from the break to finish fourth.

Trained by Marcel Barrieau, Island Beach Boy was making the second start of his career on Monday. The son of Somebeachsomewhere finished second in his career debut to Dean B Hanover on July 13.

Island Beach Boy is owned by Ian Smith and Arnold Hagen. He paid \$14.50 to win.

The second and final preliminary leg of the Dream Maker Series will take place next Monday (Aug. 3). The \$88,500 final will be contested on Aug. 10.

Gold winner P L Notsonice shatters records in Ottawa

Rideau Carleton Raceway rolled out the red carpet for Ontario's talented 3-year-old trotting fillies on Sunday (July 26) and a very fast carpet it turned out to be.

Three Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Gold Series divisions, five Grassroots divisions and one Prospect Series division went postward at the Ottawa oval and in the first \$71,467 Gold Series split **P L Notsonice** roared to a track, OSS and Canadian record 1:52.4 victory.

In rein to regular Canadian pilot Jonathan Drury, P L Notsonice left smartly from Post 5 and had command of the tempo before the :28.4 quarter. Susies Lady was quickly out to challenge P L Notsonice and the two fillies duelled to a :56.4 half before Susies Lady conceded defeat. Fan favorite P L Notsonice maintained the sharp pace through the 1:24.3

three-quarters and then drew away to a four and one-quarter length victory over pocket-sitter Trina and Shape Shifter.

The mile stripped almost three seconds off the former 3-year-old trotting filly track record of 1:55.3 set in 2004 by the great Peaceful Way and matched in 2015 by Amoureuse Hanover, and also bettered the 1:53 all-age track record for trotters set by Majestic Son in 2007. It also lowered the 1:54.2 Ontario Sires Stakes and Canadian record for 3-year-old trotting fillies on a five-eighths mile track set by Cross Of Lorraine at Georgian Downs in 2010 and matched by Miss Paris in 2012.

"It was very exciting. Ronnie (Morales) was so excited he didn't answer his phone. And he didn't watch the race he was so nervous, he watched the replay," said Norm Clements, whose Prince Lee Acres bred the filly and shares ownership on her with Renaldo "Ronnie" Morales III of Sayre, PA. "We've only got a small stable, we've been cutting way back, but this is special because it's a homebred and it's all my guys that have looked after it. It's sort of a family thing, which is really neat. So it's very exciting, we're very blessed that this has all happened."

The win was the Kadabra filly's first in Ontario Sires Stakes action and her third of the 2020 season, with her other two victories coming at Tioga Downs, where driver/trainer Morales and trainer Joseph Skowrya are based. For each of her Gold Series starts — she finished second in the July 2 season opener at Woodbine Mohawk Park — she has shipped north to race without her regular driver and trainer and then shipped back to Tioga Downs.

"We ship her from Tioga so it's not without its challenges," said Uxbridge, ON resident Clements. "But right now she's as good as anybody I guess. I'm excited to watch the next Golds. It's exciting because so many people have been involved with it and we're all, everybody is excited. I've had more phone calls on this than I've had in a long time."

In the second \$71,467 Gold division, **Warrawee Vicky** returned to the track where she learned her early lessons and snuck up the inside to claim a neck victory in 1:56. Magic Cape finished second and pacesetter and fan favorite GP Dreamin settled for third.

"I don't worry about time, she beat the best filly out there and I'm glad we got through along the rail. A win's a win and we're going to take it," said Scott McEneny, who trains Warrawee Vicky for Brad Grant. "She's getting better with the open bridle on, she's getting more relaxed. Sometimes she gets too relaxed, but I was happy with her."

Driver Doug McNair engineered Warrawee Vicky's second

Gold Series win of the season, putting the Royalty For Life daughter at the top of the division standings with a perfect 100 points.

The final \$72,266 Gold split saw **Massive Flirt** return to the provincial winner's circle just over one year since her first appearance. The Muscle Mass daughter, whose freshman campaign was cut short due to injury, controlled the pace from start to finish and held on in the stretch for a neck victory in a personal best 1:55.4. Talahassee Seelster finished second and She Rocks Kemp was third.

"It was significantly slower than the other division, the PL horse that won the first division looked bionic, but yeah, we're certainly happy to get that one," said trainer Jeff Gillis. "She's honest. She doesn't want to give up the lead, she doesn't want to make a break, she does whatever she can."

Gillis bred and owns Massive Flirt with Mac Nichol of Burlington, ON. The filly and regular reinsman Jody Jamieson were fourth in the Gold Series season opener.

Rideau Carleton Raceway regular Tyler Jones recorded his first OSS win in his provincial program debut, steering Archangel daughter **Peppas Angel** to a 2:00.1 score in the second \$22,800 Grassroots division for his father, trainer Dustin Jones of Waterdown, ON, Hebert Horses Inc. of Montreal and Andrea Lea Racing Stables Inc. of Lakefield Gore, QC. Validation finished second and Rockadero was third.

"When I saw the rail horse made a break, I said, 'Well I might as well take a shot and go to the front,' and it worked out," said Jones. "I wasn't a big favorite, so I kind of expected somebody to re-move and nobody did, and when somebody came up first-over I just drove on and she responded. Then she came back with a nice last quarter to win."

"Me and my dad were pretty happy to win together, that was pretty cool. I hadn't seen my dad in four months and his birthday is the 31st of July, so it's kind of a nice little get together to have a race and have a win together."

The other Grassroots divisions went to **Th Present** (Royalty For Life) and Bob McClure, who stopped the clock in 1:57.2 for trainer Marcel Barrieau of Cambridge, ON and Gestion Mastel Inc. of Longueuil, QC; **Pier Ho Kado** (Kadabra) and Sylvain Filion, who were 1:57.4 winners for trainer Ben Baillargeon and owners Tom and Elizabeth Rankin of St. Catharines, ON; **Profound Paragon** (Muscle Mass) and Jean Bernard Renaud, who got their second Grassroots win of the season with a 1:57.2 effort for trainer Julie Walker of Carlisle, ON and Steven Titus of Manalapan, NJ; and **HP Starlite** (Muscle Mass) and Sylvain Filion, who posted a 1:56.4 win

for trainer Daniel Martin and owners Claude Hamel of Ayer's Cliff and Guy Desautels of Montreal, QC.

The \$7,500 Prospect Series division was captured by local reinsman Guy Gagnon and **Keep Ya HeadUp**. The Archangel daughter sailed to a 1:57.3 victory for trainer Susanne Kerwood and Rene Dion of Acton, David Nicol of Mount Hope and Princeton Farms Inc. of Princeton, ON.

Ontario Sires Stakes action returns to Rideau Carleton Raceway on Sunday, Aug. 16 with Gold, Grassroots and Prospect Series divisions for the 3-year-old pacing colts.

Amigo Volo, EL Ideal strong PASS winners Sunday at Pocono

Amigo Volo and **EL Ideal**, a pair of winners of over \$500,000 last year who had not yet regained their stellar form of the previous season, showed they are now headed in the right direction by easily winning their respective \$95,367 divisions of the first preliminary of the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes for 3-year-old trotting males during the Sunday twilight card at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono.

Amigo Volo was not hustled early by Dexter Dunn, coming in from his 1:49.3 monster mile at Plainridge with Manchego, working him to the top past the :27.4 quarter and getting him to the half in :56.3. The gelding turned it up another notch to get to the three-quarters in 1:24.2 and kept pouring it on to hit the wire in 1:52, a lifetime best and only two-fifths off the track and world record of Pinkman.

Amigo Volo is quite familiar with world records, having set four of them in his freshman campaign for trainer Nifty Norman. The winner of \$684,040 for owners Pinske Stables and David J. Miller now must consider his next move, with that big race in New Jersey having eliminations this Saturday.

The Father Patrick colt EL Ideal headed a 1-2 sweep of the other division for trainer Åke Svanstedt when he posted a new best of 1:53 in winning the other Sires section. Svanstedt, handling EL Ideal, played early give-and-go with barnmate Swiss House Onfire (Dunn) past the :27.1 quarter, then posted middle splits of :56 and 1:24.1 before coming him to keep his stablemate easily at bay. The winner of \$565,712 for Emp Invest Oy is not eligible for the Hambo.

The five \$20,000 Stallion Series divisions for the sophomore trotting colts and geldings showed remarkable parity, with variance of final time ranging only from 1:54.4 and 1:55.1, and four of the five winners taking a new lifetime mark.

The one who didn't reduce his mark ironically missed by a fifth the 1:54.4 Pocono freshman trotting gelding record he set here last year. That would be the Winning Mister gelding **Town Victor**, who looped the field early under the guidance of Matt Kakaley, set all the pace, then ran off in the last quarter for his first victory of the year for trainer Rich Gillock, who co-owns the winner with Barbara Richardson.

Kakaley picked up a second StS triumph with the Father Patrick colt **Cupid Hanover**, who also took the short way around and earned himself a new mark of 1:54.4. Ron Burke conditions the 3-year-old for Elite Trotting.

Father Patrick picked up a second Stallion Series sire credit with the gelding **Solar**, who has a shiny new mark of 1:55.1 after racing on the engine and holding off the closing Steel Schooner and Secular. Marcus Miller was in the sulky for trainer/father Erv Miller and the partnership of Ervin Miller Stable Inc., Sara Miller, and John Koliopoulos.

The other Stallion Series wins were taken by sons of Explosive Matter. First was the colt **Stickler Hanover**, last year's Pennsylvania Fair Sire Stakes champion, who handled the upgrade in company nicely, lowering his record to 1:54.4 as he has now won four of his last five for driver Brady Brown, trainer Steve Schoeffel, and owners Virginia and Kathy Schoeffel.

The gelding **Arclight Hanover** also matched the fastest Stallion Series time of 1:54.4, a lifetime best, as he cut the mile then held off the late thrust of S Class for driver Jason Bartlett and trainer Mark Harder, the latter co-owner with Deena Rachel Frost and Emma Pettersson.

Caviart Eva pulled off a big upset at odds of 30-1 in the first filly division, gunning down 2-5 favorite Next Level Stuff by a nose in 1:52.1, a lifetime best for the Trixton-Caviart Elle product, who was driven by Andy McCarthy for trainer Nancy Takter.

In the lone dash for colts and geldings, 10-1 chance Rome Pays Off (Muscle Hill—Order By Wish), driven by Mattias Melander for his brother Marcus, scored in a lifetime-best 1:52.3, possibly punching his ticket to take a shot in The Hambletonian. Play Trix On Me, the 3-2 favorite, was 2¾ lengths behind at the wire to finish second.

bankrolled \$21,875 in his young career. The son of Swan For All—Sunday Yankee is owned in partnership by David McDuffee and L&L Devisser. Swingforthefences was bred by Concord Stud Farm.

The upset trend continued in the second division of the stakes action as **Breckenridge** and Dan Shetler sprung the 7-1 upset. Scoring in 1:58.1, Breckenridge made his game winning move down the backside and trotted strong to the wire to capture his maiden breaking score.

After making a break behind the gate in his career debut last week, Shetler eased Breckenridge off the gate to settle along the rail in fifth through the opening quarter in :28. When the field straightened away down the backside, the heavily favored Gucci Goo and Michael Oosting were calling the shots and Shetler had his mount pointed to the front. Breckenridge reached command at the third station in 1:29 and trotted strong to the wire to keep the pocket-sitting Gucci Goo at bay.

“He’s had a little trouble with his manners behind the gate,” trainer / driver Dan Shetler noted after the victory. “Once you get him out of there, he’s fine. He’s a very nice colt who has plenty of ability, just needs to mind his manners.”

With the win, the son of Class Included—Dazzling Miss recorded his first win from two lifetime outs. Breckenridge is owned in partnership by Dojea Stables and Dan Shetler, who also bred the colt in connection with Sawgrass Farms, LLC.

Racing returns to Harrah's Philadelphia on this afternoon (July 29), with a \$14,305.50 carryover in the fifth-race Jackpot Hi-5. Post time is 12:25 p.m.

Batavia Downs begins its 2020 season today

The 74th season of live harness racing at Batavia Downs kicks off this afternoon (July 29) and opening day features some of the best horses on the grounds, including the open filly and mare pacers and the open class trotters. Post time for the first race is 5 p.m.

The Downs will conduct a 43-day meet in 2020 that for the first week will race on Wednesday (July 29) and Friday (July 31) before changing to a Wednesday/Saturday schedule for the remainder of the meet. Post time for Wednesdays is 5 p.m. and Saturdays is 6 p.m. Post time for Friday (July 31) is 5 p.m.

There are two special Sunday matinee cards that will be held on Aug. 2 and Aug. 9 when the New York Sire Stakes come to town. Those cards will feature all-stake races that will see the 2- and 3-year old trotting fillies compete on Sunday (Aug. 2) and the 2- and 3-year-old pacing colts and geldings go to the gate on Sunday (Aug. 9). Post time for both of these dates is 1:15 p.m.

The New York Sire Stakes will be the only stake races at the Downs this year as the track's signature race, the \$50,000 Robert J. Kane Pace, will not be contested in 2020.

"We look forward to another exciting race meet," said Henry Wojtaszek, president and CEO of Western Regional Off-Track Betting, the owner of Batavia Downs. "During these difficult times, we've made a series of adjustments that we hope will lead to a successful season."

There will be no fans allowed to attend the races at this point due to ongoing concerns and New York State regulations surrounding the Coronavirus. However, listed owners of horses in to go will be allowed on the track apron starting opening night as per New York State Gaming Commission regulations.

Listed owners must make a reservation to attend in advance and be put on a list that will allow them to enter. Reservations must be made 24 hours before race time by calling Mary Bucceri at 585.344.6144 or by emailing your request to mbucceri@westernotb.com. Listed owners who register will receive an e-mail confirmation. Security will only let in those who are on the list. There will be no food or beverage service available however owners may bring food, water or soft drinks in until the gaming floor opens.

Upon arriving at the Downs, a temperature check and health status questionnaire must be completed by each listed owner in the lobby. Once that process is complete you must then proceed through the Park Place Event Center hallway to the apron. No one is allowed to walk through the gaming floor to the apron. Also there is no access to the second floor unless you are a hotel guest.

Anyone coming to the track as a visiting owner on the apron or as a trainer, driver or groom in the barn area or paddock must wear a mask at all times and practice social distancing. This will be strictly enforced.

Listed owners only will be allowed in the winner's circle for pictures if their horse wins while wearing a mask and practicing social distancing.

Also please be aware that any horsemen or owners coming from states that are on the New York State Coronavirus Quarantine List are not allowed to Batavia Downs attend at any time.

Wagering will be available at all WROTB branch or EZ Bet locations, WROTB Dial-a-Bet System for account holders and online at bataviabets.com. The Downs signal is also simulcast to a vast number of brick and mortar and ADW betting sites and may also be wagered on through them. Replays of the Downs races can be viewed the following day at bataviadownsgaming.com, where all Downs racing information can also be found.

On the track, all the local horsepeople will be back including 2019 driving champion Billy Davis Jr., Jim Morrill Jr., Dave McNeight III, Drew Monti, Shawn McDonough and Ray Fisher Jr. On the training side, last year's conditioning champ Jim Clouser Jr. brings his stable back along with Maria Rice, Gerry Sarama, Mike Ohol and Ryan Swift.

"This is definitely going to be a different year for us," said Todd Haight, director/general manager of live racing at Batavia Downs. "Without fans allowed in the stands, we won't have any promotions this year like our traditional dollar hot dog and draft days, Family Fun days including the wiener dog races, nightly giveaways and our Labor Day

driver's bike race that goes back to 1978. Right now we are happy that the horsemen can continue to work and hope that with constantly improving Covid test numbers in the state, we may welcome back our guests at some point before the meet ends."

The 2020 meet runs through Saturday (Dec. 12).

The harness racing will be conducted in accordance with the protocols of the "Safe Return to Racing" as established by the Ohio State Racing Commission.

The Delaware County Fair will hold a virtual, online sale for the 2020 Junior Fair. The Junior Fair Sale Committee is still finalizing details and will announce more information as it becomes available.

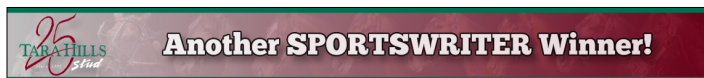
