around the idea of maybe COSA-TV coming down to do a show because I believe at the time CBS didn't have airtime for the Hambletonian," said MacDonald. "Moira wanted to do more than just a simulcast show. A simulcast show serves a purpose for handicappers, but she wanted the entertainment value of a network-style show like what we do for COSA-TV.

Up until this point, the Hambletonian has long had its own TV show, even if it wasn't always live.

For a brief time this year, there was a real possibility that the streak would end, but the show will go on.

Curtis MacDonald's Cujo Entertainment will be producing the show that will be shot on Hambletonian Day and aired on the CBS Sports Network (CBSSN) on Sunday, Aug. 21, from 5:30-6:30 p.m.

"It's more of a historical hour that features the 97th Hambo and Oaks," said Moira Fanning, director of publicity/chief operating officer of the Hambletonian Society.


With so much content flooding the tube these days, it was initially difficult to get an hour-long block of time for the historic race. For example, at 6:35 p.m., off time for the Hambletonian on Saturday, Aug. 6, CBSSN will be showing 3ICE, live three-on-three professional ice hockey action.

"When the planning started for the Hambletonian, I was asked to do the cable cam again and then we threw

"If you're betting, the simulcast show is great because Dave [Brower] and Dave [Little] and whoever else give you what their selections are and all the handicapping type things, but a lot of people just want to sit back and watch it. They want to be entertained. Whether it's two, three, four hours, whatever it is, they want something to be entertaining and that's where COSA-TV kind of has a bit of a niche. We do that. We cover all kinds of events in Ontario, where we do it strictly for the entertainment value. Now yes, we do show the odds and we talk about handicapping, but we focus on the people in the paddock. We focus on the stories. We typically will do a feature or two per show where we highlight the horses in the race. So, it's kind of more of an entertainment show than a simulcast show."

With CBS originally off the table, the Hambletonian would still be shown live on Fox Sports 1 [FS1] as part of Saratoga Live presented by America's Best Racing, but it wouldn't be a standalone production.

"But then CBS came back and said, 'We'll give you a primetime hour the following week if you want to do a kind of historical Hambletonian and recap of the Hambo Oaks," said Fanning. "We all agreed that the Hambletonian deserved a little more focus than whatever America's Best Racing could squeeze in or not squeeze in and to look at the 97th Hambo, you shouldn't have to page through 16 Meadowlands races to find it."

For MacDonald, it's a great honor to be producing the sport's biggest race and to again be part of their biggest day.

"It's actually funny," said MacDonald. "I was talking with my wife [Jaimi] about this the other day and I said probably in 2018 – or something around there – we went and did work for Harness Racing Update to cover the Hambletonian. And every year since, minus COVID, it seems like we've been more involved



with the Hambletonian. In 2020, Greg [Blanchard] and I went out and shot a feature on Luc Blais, because they won in 2019 [with Forbidden Trade]. So, we shot a feature on Luc Blais and Bob McClure to show on the CBS Hambletonian show. Then, in 2021, I went down and did the cable cam and now this year we're doing a show. It seems like we went from just watching it on TV here in Canada to having a little bit of involvement and now we're really heavily involved."

Just as he did for the 2021 Breeders Crown, MacDonald will be live streaming on Hambletonian Day as part of COSA-TV, which will broadcast live from 3:00-5:15 p.m., then take a 45-minute break where they will show the feed of the Big M simulcast show, before coming back live at 5:55 p.m. with the show for CBSSN.

Throughout COSA-TV's broadcast, which will be hosted by Greg Blanchard, with Michael Carter in the paddock, MacDonald will utilize additional equipment, such as a super slow-motion camera at the finish line, to add to the experience.

"We add a bunch of extra cameras that don't necessarily fit in simulcast, because with simulcast you want to see the race," said MacDonald. "You want to see where the horses are at all times because you've got money on that.

"We're trying to entertain you and give you those up close, tight shots that are more entertaining to watch than a simulcasttype show."

For the CBSSN hour-long delayed retrospective, Greg Blanchard and The Meadowlands' own Dave Brower will be at the desk with Michael Carter in the paddock.



Hambletonian Day picks and analysis

Breaking down
Saturday's huge stakes
lineup at The Meadowlands.

An attractive wagering menu and competitive fields all day long make for the potential of strong payouts for Saturday's Hambletonian Day card at The Meadowlands. Here are tickets for how I see some of the horizontal wagers being played out.

Races 3 through 7, \$0.50 Pick 5 (\$75,000 guaranteed pool) \$0.50 ticket: 1-2 / 1-3-9 / 5 / 2-3-8-10 / 6-7 \$24

RACE 3, DR. JOHN STEELE MEMORIAL \$145,000

In an identical rematch to last week's Ms. Versatility, ATLANTA looks to keep it rolling after her easy 1:50 score. Her odds of 3-1 that night were her highest for as long as I can remember and while this remains a small but competitive group, the role of favorite may now default back to her. BELLA BELLINI was never going to win last week but she was also unable to pass a 48-1 longshot for second. Though, overall, she has been sensational all summer long. WHEN DOVESCRY seems to be the only other mare who could reasonably win this. It just depends on how DM wants to handle the outside post.

RACE 4, MUSCLE HILL \$50,000

VILLIAN wasn't beaten by much in May to Hambletonian contender Temporal Hanover and has the speed to get involved despite the outside post. TESTING TESTING was a 1:52 winner at Vernon three back in which he beat King Of The North and also finds class relief. He won a Breeders Crown elimination

here last year. JUSTICE kept up well enough against faster foes last week in his Hambletonian elimination. We will see if his New York success can translate into a win here. Both TORRONE and KOSHER MAHONEY have flirted with stakes competition at times.

RACE 5, PETER HAUGHTON MEMORIAL – FINAL \$337,000

CARTER MICHAEL DEO flew from out of the clouds last week and that came in his first race since moving to the Burke stable; seems dangerous. KILMISTER delivered as the favorite last week in the Haughton elimination to remain unbeaten early in his career; couldn't have had a better trip. OH WELL won his New Jersey Sires Stakes final last out though Tetrick was after him to hang on; anxious to see if that driver stays here or opts to another Melander trainee, UPSTAGED. CELEBRITY BAMBINO was never close last out at 9-5; tough call based on those last two and the outside post.

RACE 6, CONTINENTAL VICTORY \$33,500

MONKEY QUEEN made a good account for herself when last seen in the middle of July when she ran second to the colt, Letsdoit S. She did outsprint Oaks finalist Pink Coco Chanel in that race and that should count for something. MISSWALNER FASHION has run into breaking issues but at her best is more than fast enough; it's a big "if" but a flat mile should win it. LILBITALEXIS is another that's seen her stock fall a notch this year but this another one taking a big drop; could easily wake back up. DELILAH HANOVER is another that is more than a threat when at her best. GRACELYN HANOVER was a game winner two back.

RACE 7, SHADY DAISY \$92,300

BOUDOIR HANOVER has been caught at the wire twice in a row, but both those defeats were high-level efforts coming off that 1:48.3 win in the Nadia Lobell. She can turn the table on her newfound rival. MAX CONTRACT proved that her rally in the Mistletoe Shalee was no fluke. She came home in :26 last week after initially being resigned to sit third on the inside before getting a clear path at the top of the lane. What do we do with TREACHEROUS DRAGON? Just 1 for 3 since moving barns and was tiring late at the end of her most recent mile; has to take an early shot again from out here. GALLERIA HANOVER and LYONS SERENITY dueled early last out in the Adioo Volo, a race that was won by a big longshot off second-over cover. I thought SMUGGLE TINA would have been a bit better last out at the Meadows.

Races 8 through 11, \$0.50 Early Pick 4 (\$100,000 guaranteed pool)

\$0.50 ticket: 6-8 / 7 / 1-8-9 / 9-10-11 \$9

RACE 8, CANE PACE \$275,000

BEACH GLASS was super here in winning the Meadowlands Pace two weeks ago as well as winning his Pace elimination the week prior. It took a massive effort by the lesser known but highly talented Bythemissal to beat him in the Adios; seeks to remain sharp in his fifth start in as many weeks. NIGHT HAWK seems like he's deserved better of late. He was hard used without much of a breather in the Meadowlands Pace; he can still win this with a reasonable journey. MAD MAX HANOVER has always shown talent and is now streaking in the right direction, coming off back-to-back 1:47.4 miles. CAPTAIN COWBOY tried to press the tempo early in the Pace and it didn't work out; a possibility if the race sets up for a closer. FOUREVER BOY closed strongly in his Pace elimination four back.

RACE 9, LADY LIBERTY \$173,000

TEST OF FAITH comes off that 1:47 mile which was taken moments before it was followed up by that 1:45.4 mile by Bulldog Hanover on Pace night. There isn't any real reason to play against, though strange upsets are bound to happen on this day. FIRE START HANOVER has turned into somewhat of a project this year for Nifty Norman; is still good enough to land a share like she did a couple races back. HOT MESS EXPRESS returned a winner after being off a month in what served as a prep for this race. LYONS SENTINEL overpowered them at

Plainridge but it's back to a similar position from the Dorothy Haughton she found herself in; at the mercy of the pace? RACINE BELL gave way rather tamely in the Barton. AMAZING DREAM N looks slated to pick up Sears.

RACE 10, SAM MCKEE MEMORIAL \$278,000

ABUCKABETT HANOVER has been "charging hard" in his last pair of races. Whatever the reason, the times seen at the Meadowlands this season have been unprecedented and this horse might be the first one ever to show back-to-back:24.4 final quarters (and be no better than fourth in either of them). He finally lands a decent post and will need it to stave off #9. ROCKYROAD HANOVER shined on this day here last year in the Cane Pace and was as game as can be last out when he chased home Bulldog Hanover in that all-time mile. Post draw continues to be unkind to him. WORKIN ONA MYSTERY continues to fire in nearly every start and will be in the mix. POSEIDON SEELSTER has been here before and blitzed them last out at Woodbine; his speed may play well here for Brennan. CATCH THE FIRE exits a fast win at Pocono.

RACE 11, VINCENNES \$60,000

An oddity for INCOMMUNICADO two races ago when the starting gate forced him to start inside the pylons refunding all wagers on him. Then last out he was the victim of a hopeless shuffle at Plainridge. He was supported down to 5-1 in that race which included many horses starring in the Cashman Memorial on this race card. Will still have to work out a trip from the second tier now, but seems overdue for something more. VENERATE goes from Pinske to Julie Miller and that seems like something worth keeping an eye on; would have to think he'll be leaving early from the outside. AMIGO VOLO continues to go strong and has been mixing it up at Yonkers at times with both HILLEXOTIC and STORMY KROMER. TAKE ALL COMERS has been facing stiff competition and I'd consider this a drop.

Races 12 through 15, \$0.50 Late Pick 4 (\$125,000 guaranteed pool)

\$0.50 ticket: 5 / 1-2-5-6 / 3-4-5 / 1-2 \$12

RACE 12, HAMBLETONIAN OAKS - FINAL \$500.000

VENERABLE has returned to form that saw her storm through her 2-year-old season and in my opinion is the one to beat in the Oaks final. She was slowly getting to Joviality two back in the Del Miller and last week's elimination win was never in doubt. WARRAWEE XENIA made it 7 in a row with her win last week and for much of the race it didn't look like she had any business of being close, let alone winning. But McClure found room, navigated near a breaker and surged late; anxious to see if she can replicate the feat. FASHION SCHOONER looked clear in her elimination before maybe being somewhat blindsided to the oncoming Canadian invader. Was a 1:50.1 winner two back but this suddenly won't be an easy task from post 10. MANON couldn't sustain late in her mile last out after having to come first-over from fourth; can bounce back and should be forwardly placed.

RACE 13, JIM DOHERTY - FINAL \$355,000

Maybe easy to say after the fact, but UNA MADONNA won as a massive overlay in the Doherty elimination last week. A solid winner at Oak Grove in June, she made her second start last out for Alagna (broke in the first one) and was loaded with all sorts of trot after Bongiorno waited patiently for a seam to open. Price will obviously be shorter now, but I don't think that race was a fluke. MAMBACITA is the other Tactical Landing filly in here along with #1, and there's nothing wrong with the start of her career either. Gave game chase to Walner Payton last out in her NJSS Final; though worth noting that winner came back to be just fourth earlier this week as a big favorite at the Red Mile. ROYAL FILLY was aggressively handled last week vacating



the two-hole early; eventually seemed clear but was caught. INSTAGRAM MODEL was well supported last week despite an outside post; closed evenly in that race as did SECRET VOLO.

RACE 14, JOHN CASHMAN MEMORIAL \$279,000


Svanstedt trains five of the eight in this field, and I'd say is led by two in particular that have made the largest impressions in minimal starts. ECURIE D was resounding upon arrival in just a couple of starts last year and debuted this year to a 1:49.1 win in the Cutler. But then a month later, he lost at 1/9 odds in the Crawford Farms to stablemate ALRAJAH ONE IT who swept home with a :25.3 final guarter in his North American debut to win going away in 1:50.4. I have no idea who will be better on Saturday; not sure if Ake does either. CUATRO DE JULIO raced too good to lose in the Hambo Maturity and now gets some post relief; a possible threat to beat the Svanstedt guintet. RATTLE MY CAGE faced pressure in the Maturity and gave way; has been sharp in all other starts this year. AMBASSADOR HANOVER continues to close well. LOVEDBYTHEMASSES did some of the harder work last out in the Spirt Of Mass in what was a solid effort; has come a long way since the start of last winter.

RACE 15, HAMBLETONIAN - FINAL \$1,000,000

It's somehow been already 10 years since Tetrick won his lone Hambletonian with Market Share, and he's in a prime position to make another one with REBUFF. Last year's Breeders Crown champion has been a model of professionalism in his three starts this year, highlighted by that 1:49.3 mile two back in the Dancer. He's the one to beat and will warrant his favoritism. Perhaps a chink in the armor from JOVIALITY, though she had things taken to her last week in her elimination from post 10 and never got off easy. If anything, maybe that race will serve her well as she looks to become the third filly in the last five years to win this race; driver Sears is seeking his fourth Hambo and first since 2015 when he was in the role of beating a filly (Mission Brief) with Pinkman. TEMPORAL HANOVER gave a stern challenge last week to Joviality and eventually did wear down that foe. He's fired in every start this year as one of three Melander finalists here and Orjan Kihlstrom will get the return drive. Dexter Dunn had a tough decision to make and he went with the other filly in this race, elimination winner JIGGY JOG S who split rivals late to pull off that upset. With Dunn going there, Gingras picks up the drive on FAST AS THE WIND who was second to Rebuff in his elimination; was strong earlier in the summer in Canada though did win the Valley Victory here to close out last year.









Swedish top driver Örjan Kihlström



relishes the chance to add a Hambletonian victory to his resume

A win Saturday with Temporal Hanover would make him the first driver to win the Hambletonian, Elitloppet and Prix d'Amerique.

Swedish top driver Örjan Kihlström has been in the harness racing game since he was a young child. The Kihlström family was well known in the business and it was more or less obvious that Örjan, born in 1962, would devote his life to horses and harness racing.

Much can be said about Kihlström and why he has reached the position as one of the best harness racing drivers in Europe, but one word comes to mind to describe him: humility.

His success on the track has never changed him and he often credits his magnificent career to all the great horses he's been privileged to drive throughout the years.

Kihlström has been called "the king of big races" in Sweden and somewhat jokingly it is said he never really wakes up until the purse surpasses a specific high amount in the races. That is the exaggerated hype about him, because Kihlström is a top professional in everything he does and whatever race he's driving in.

Saturday, he will be back at Meadowlands to race Marcus Melander trainee Temporal Hanover in the Hambletonian. Last week, Kihlström crossed the Atlantic and qualified the trotter for the \$1 million final with a second-place finish in his

elimination that was just a head back of winning filly Jiggy Jog S.

"It's very rare that you get to drive such a good horse in a race like this and in addition, the schedule back home in Sweden suited me well these two weekends," Kihlström said. "That is one of the biggest obstacles for me driving in other countries — the schedule with all the horses I drive in Sweden."

Kihlström said he learned a lot driving Temporal Hanover last Saturday.

"I already knew that he's a really good horse, a complete trotter who is easy to drive and what I learned from the race Saturday was that he just simply is as good as I thought. I've never had such a great shot in Hambletonian before, so this will be very exciting for me."

Kihlström has raced in the Hambletonian three times prior — twice for Melander. In 2018, Kihlström had his best result, finishing fourth in his elimination and fifth in the final driving





Evaluate for Melander. He also was ninth in his elimination driving Cruzado Dela Noche in 2015 for trainer Nancy Takter. Most recently, he was seventh in his elimination driving Gerry for Melander in 2019.

However, Kihlström has tasted success on American soil before. Even as a trainer he tried his luck in The International Trot at Yonkers in 1990. That time it ended with fifth-place finish, but Kihlström has also won some prestigious races in the USA. In 2014, he steered Commander Crowe to victory in the \$500,000 Breeders Crown at The Meadowlands.

"I've driven some big races in America before, Hambletonian included, and it's exciting to experience these kind of race days."

Kihlström is one of the best-known European drivers in North America and he said the Hambletonian is one of the three biggest races in the world to win.

"For us Europeans, or Swedes, the Elitloppet is really big and that's the race many drivers and trainers dream about to win. And then we have Prix d'Amérique, obviously. But the Hambletonian is as big as the other two races and, with 21 years of reflection, Scarlet Knight's and Stefan Melander's win in the race in 2001 was a big feat, hard to repeat for anyone today. That was just an amazing victory for the sport and I guess it will be very tough for someone else to achieve something like that again," Kihlström said.

A victory on Saturday would put Kihlström in unchartered territory. He would become the first driver to win the Hambletonian, Elitloppet and Prix d'Amerique.

Kihlström said American racing fans are fairly knowledgeable about European racing.

"It seems like people in the business keep up with what's going on in Europe and yes, they seem to recognize me when I'm at The Meadowlands. I've come to know some of the drivers in America in connection to Elitloppet and World Driving Championship and they're all super professional guys who are very good drivers."

As for racing in America, Kihlström said it is a bit of an adjustment.

"First of all, we barely have any mile tracks, so it starts there with some differences in how to drive. I also notice that the driving culture is quite different from Europe," he said. "But it just requires you to watch and learn and I can promise that all

the top drivers in America would adapt to the Swedish system pretty quickly if they started to race there more frequently."

Kihlström said the first North American driver he was impressed with was one of the legends of the game.

"Before the Internet and everything, when you had to visit the tracks to see new horses and drivers, I got to see Joe O'Brien and he really had something extra when he drove a horse. Then, some years later, John D Campbell showed up at Solvalla and he is probably one of the best drivers ever in the sport. And I must say that all the top drivers that we see in America today, they're all very talented," Kihlström said.







Key players in the Hambletonian

Lucas Wallin, trainer of the Hambletonian favorite Rebuff, is in the very unusual position of having driven in his first Hambletonian (2021 Cuatro De Julio) before having a trainee in the race.

Will he or countryman Swede Marcus Melander, become the sixth Swede to win the Hambletonian?

If so, Wallin or Melander would join:

Stefan Melander (1)

Jan Johnson (1)

Ake Svanstedt (2)

Per Eriksson (3)

And Jimmy Takter (4)

Tim Tetrick is looking for his second Hambletonian 10 years after he first won it with Market Share.

Tetrick is driving in his 16th straight Hambletonian final. His record is 1-3-1, with earnings of \$2,223,100 in that race alone.

Rebuff's part-breeder Steve Stewart is trying for yet another Hambletonian win to go with the ones he had in 2014 with Trixton and in 2019 with Forbidden Trade.

Rebuff's sire, Muscle Hill, is looking for his fourth Hambletonian and will be sending out his fourth Hambletonian favorite.

JOVIALITY

Marcus Melander is the only trainer with four straight Hambletonian checks while in his 20s (2017-2018-2019-2020)

All three of Brian Sears' Hambletonian wins came while he was in his 40s:

He was 41 in 2009 when he won with Muscle Hill, 45 in 2013 when he won with Royalty For Life and 47 in 2015 when he won with Pinkman.

All three of the Hambletonian-winning drives for Sears also won their eliminations.

Joviality has very similar past performance lines as a sophomore as Duenna did coming into the Hambletonian:

Joviality's previous four races before last week were at Vernon twice and Yonkers twice. Duenna had raced at four New York

tracks in five starts prior to her 1983 upset — two at Buffalo, one each at Monticello, Roosevelt and Saratoga.

The last time a filly won the Yonkers Trot and then tried the Hambletonian was in 1996 when Continental victory set a two-heat 3:45 world record while winning the Hambletonian.

At a win rate of 79 per cent, Joviality is the only Hambletonian finalist over 50 per cent lifetime in 2022.

Chapter Seven is trying to join Stars Pride as the sire of two Hambletonian-winning fillies (he had Atlanta in 1958). Stars Pride had Emilys Prise in 1958 and

Kerrys Way in 1966.

HAMBLETONIAN SHORTS

The year 1975 was the first year betting was allowed on the Hambletonian Oaks.

* * *

Jim Campbell and Joe Holloway were the only trainers on the 2022 elimination card who also were active on the Mack Lobell 1987 Hambletonian Day card 35 years ago. Campbell had Freight Saver and Holloway had Banker Blue Chip.

* * *

It's been 14 years since the top three finishers in the Hambletonian were all USA born trainers:

In 2008, Ray Schnittker was first and third. Frank Antonacci was second.

* * *

It's been 34 years since John Campbell went back-to-back as a driver in the Hambletonian. Since then, 11 times the winning driver did not appear the following year — of the 22 that did, zero won, three finished second and one third.

The last trotter to have a \$2 million season did so thanks to the last Hambletonian that went for a purse of \$1.5 million — Market Share in 2012.

Can anyone remember who the first horse that Mal Burroughs raced in the Hambletonian? Not Malabar Man the 1997 winner. He owned J Ds Tryst who in 1982 broke stride early and was ninth in his heat.

The 1983 Hambletonian was the first \$1 million Hambletonian (\$1,080,000). Then, 48 hours later, the \$1.7 million Woodrow Wilson was contested on a Monday night (won by Carls Bird).

Bill O'Donnell won with Prakas in 1985 in a record 1:54.3. I guess you could say his first four Hambletonian drives were just warn-ups:

Jason Bartlett will come into Hambletonian Day as the #1 moneywinning driver in North America. It has proven to be something of a Sports illustrated Jinx, though, to the Hambletonian drivers. Orjan Kihlstrom at 60 will try to be the oldest first-time Hambletonian winning driver in Meadowlands history with Temporal Hanover:

Roger Hammer was 59 in 2005 when he won with Vivid Photo Ake Svanstedt was 58 in 2017 when he won with Perfect Spirit Mal Burroughs was 56 when he won in 1997 with Malabar Man If you added up the U.S.-born trainers in the last five Hambletonians you would not have a full field. Just nine of the 50 finalists (18 per cent) have been trained by American-born conditioners.

If Venerable wins the Oaks, trainer Nifty Norman would become the only trainer ever to win the Oaks back to back twice.

He won in 2012 and 2013 with Personal Style and Bee A Magician, respectively.

Wallin could capture both the Oaks and the Hambletonian.

Bar Hopping would be the first sire in the 52-year history of the Oaks to sire the winner from his first two crops.

If Pink Coco Chanel wins the Oaks, Cantab Hall would get his third Oaks credit. He won it back to back in 2014 and 2015 with Lifetime Pursuit and Wild Honey.

Nancy Takter won the 2020 Oaks and is the only trainer with two shots in 2022 with Selfie Queen and Mon Cheval (her dam Shake It Cerry was fourth in the 2014 Oaks).

If Bare My Soul wins the Oaks, driver Yannick Gingras would record his record seventh Oaks.

Five trainers with chance at Hambletonian-Oaks double

Since the inception of the Hambletonian Oaks in 1971 as the filly companion event to the Hambletonian Stakes for

3-year-old trotters, two trainers — Jan Johnson and Jimmy Takter — have won both races on the same day.

Johnson accomplished the feat in 1988 with Nan's Catch in the Oaks and Armbro Goal in the Hambletonian. Takter did it twice, first in 2014 with Lifetime Pursuit and Trixton, and again in 2015 with Wild Honey and Pinkman.

On Saturday at The Meadowlands, five trainers will have the opportunity to add their name to the list. Tony Alagna, Jim Campbell, Ake Svanstedt, Nancy Takter, and Lucas Wallin each have at least one starter in both the \$500,000 Hambletonian Oaks and \$1 million Hambletonian. It is the highest number of trainers with a starter in both races this century, and perhaps in history.

Following is a brief look at each trainer's hopefuls in the two classic races.

TONY ALAGNA - HAMBLETONIAN, FAST AS THE WIND; OAKS, PINK COCO CHANEL


Fast As The Wind, who won the Goodtimes Stakes in June and last year's Valley Victory Stakes and Kindergarten Classic Series championship, is 8-1 on the morning line in the Hambletonian. He was second to Hambletonian favorite Rebuff in his elimination after his only two off-the-board finishes in eight starts this year.

"We've been fighting some bloodwork issues with him, which we went through last year with him a little bit, but he was much better," said Alagna, who won the 2020 Hambletonian with filly Ramona Hill. "I think he's definitely on the improve.

"He's grown up so much (from age 2 to 3). He's really filled out. He's a gorgeous animal. You can't not appreciate what he looks like, that's for sure."

Pink Coco Chanel was unraced at 2 and competed in conditioned classes ahead of her Oaks elimination, where she finished third behind Warrawee Xenia and Fashion Schooner. She has hit the board in five of six starts, winning one. She is 12-1.

"I couldn't be more proud of her," Alagna said. "She just needed some time (last year). She was just immature, mentally and



physically. I think she will continue to get better the more we race her. She's just playing catch-up a little bit trying to get the experience these other fillies have got."

JIM CAMPBELL – HAMBLETONIAN, COOL PAPA BELL; OAKS, FASHION SCHOONER

Cool Papa Bell has hit the board in 13 of 16 lifetime starts. He has six wins, with five coming in the New York Sire Stakes. He is 15-1 after finishing third behind Rebuff and Fast As

The Wind in his elimination.

"I was real happy with the way he raced," said Campbell, a Hambletonian winner with Tagliabue in 1995 and Oaks winner with Broadway Schooner in 2009. "He stalled a little bit around the last turn, but then he got going through the stretch and trotted home real good. Now we just have to hope for a good trip in the final.

"He's just a real nice horse to be around. I'd take a barnful of him"

Fashion Schooner, whose mom is Broadway Schooner, was limited to three starts at 2 after dealing with sickness. She is this year's New Jersey Sire Stakes champion and won a division of the Delvin Miller Memorial. She finished second to lateclosing Warrawee Xenia in her elimination and is 4-1 in the Oaks final after drawing post 10.

"I thought we had the race wrapped up, and (Warrawee Xenia) came flying from out of nowhere," Campbell said. "I wasn't disappointed in her. I thought she put in a good race.

"You never know how good one is going to be, but she showed us enough last year where we thought that if everything worked right for her, she had the ability to do it. She has high speed, she's good gaited, gets over the ground good, and she's got a good attitude. She likes to race."

AKE SVANSTEDT - HAMBLETONIAN, JIGGY JOG S; OAKS, BAPTISM

Jiggy Jog S, one of two fillies in the Hambletonian, won her elimination by a head over Temporal Hanover and a neck over the other filly, Joviality S. She has four wins, including the Zweig Memorial Main Event for 3-year-old fillies and New York New York Mile, and two seconds this season. She has six victories in 17 career starts. She is 4-1 in the final.

"She raced good," said Svanstedt, who won last year's Hambletonian with Captain Corey and in 2017 with Perfect Spirit. "(Driver Dexter Dunn) said she won with a lot of power left also. He didn't need to ask her nothing. She just did it herself. That was good. This was her most impressive race."

Baptism, who has multiple victories on the Pennsylvania stakes circuit and won a Reynolds Memorial division in July, finished fifth in her Oaks elimination. She is 15-1 in the final.

"She needs a better trip to compete," Svanstedt said. "She hadn't raced in a long time, so maybe she can be sharper (in the final). I'm happy she made the final. She can perform better."

NANCY TAKTER - HAMBLETONIAN, KEG STAND AND LOOKS LIKE MONI; OAKS, MON CHEVAL AND SELFIE QUEEN

Keg Stand and Looks Like Moni both reached the Hambletonian final as fifth-place finishers. Keg Stand, who is 10-1, has two wins, both in the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes, in three starts this season while Looks Like Moni, who is 15-1, has a win in eight starts.

"I was super happy with (Keg Stand)," said Takter, who won the 2020 Oaks with Sorella. "He hasn't raced in this type of competition before, so it was nice to see that he seemed to belong. He was full of trot finishing.

"He trained super all winter and qualified really well. I scoped him just to see how he was, and he had an (epiglottal) entrapment. So, we had to do entrapment surgery and it was a little complicated and took extra time. I didn't think he was going to make the Hambletonian, but he earned his way there.

"(Looks Like Moni) is pretty versatile. He can leave, he can sit, so I think that's his strong suit. He's kind of handy, so that's good."

Selfie Queen and Mon Cheval both advanced to the Oaks final as fourth-place finishers. Selfie Queen, the Kentucky Championship Series winner last year and second-fastest 2-year-old trotter of the season, has won five of 15 races lifetime and is 10-1. Mon Cheval, a five-time winner on the Pennsylvania stakes trail and a Tompkins-Geers division winner in July, is 15-1.

"I think definitely (Selfie Queen) should take a step forward with another start under her belt. It's just a matter of her wanting to do her work next week," Takter said. "That's what it comes down to. She's got the speed and the talent, she just needs to have it all come together at once.

"(Mon Cheval) raced good. (Driver Andrew McCarthy) said she had plenty of trot finishing, but he went to the inside, and she was a little hesitant. There was no room to go to the outside and sometimes horses aren't really used to passing on the inside and she just kind of took herself up a little bit. But I was very happy with her."

LUCAS WALLIN – HAMBLETONIAN, REBUFF; OAKS, MANON

Rebuff won his Hambletonian elimination and is the 9-5 favorite in the final. Manon finished fifth in her Oaks elimination, her only finish worse than second in seven starts this season. She has five victories.

"I think off a helmet, (Rebuff) is as fast as any trotter I've driven," said driver Tim Tetrick, who won the Hambletonian in 2012 with Market Share and the Oaks in 2010 with Bar Slide and in 2007 with Danae. "On the front, he looks around and goofs off and waits for somebody to get to him. It's looks deceiving, like he's done, but he's not even close to being done."

Said Wallin about Manon, "We're probably going to pull the shoes and put pop outs on her for the first time and also make some changes on the bridle (for the final). We've been waiting for the right race, and now we feel this is the right race to do it."

Hambletonian Day at The Big M: All you need to know

There's a reason Christmas only comes once a year. The same can be said for Hambletonian Day at The Meadowlands, which is Saturday (Aug. 6).

It's so special, you couldn't do anything this big more than once every 12 months.

The drama will begin with a special early post time of noon when the field for the first of 16 action-packed races heads to the gate. There are 10 stakes events sprinkled throughout the day, headlined by the \$1 million Hambletonian and \$500,000 Hambletonian Oaks.

A big crowd is likely, with temperatures expected to be in the mid-80s.

"There is nothing in harness racing like Hambletonian Day," said Meadowlands' chief operating officer and general manager Jason Settlemoir. "And I recommend to anyone that can to be with us live on track. The greatest stars from all over the world. The top horses in every division. The excitement. The food. The live music. A drawing for a grand prize of \$10,000 for our Masterminds contest. This card will produce our biggest handle – and very likely, our biggest attendance – of 2022. So, for horseplayers, they get to play in what will be our biggest pools of the year. The Big M is the place to be this Saturday."

WHERE TO WATCH: For those who cannot make it out to the track, The Hambletonian will be shown live on Fox Sports 1 (FS1) as part of the New York Racing Association's presentation of "Saratoga Live". Post time for The Hambletonian is 6:35 p.m. The on-track pregame show with Dave Brower and Dave Little kicks off at 11:30 a.m. The in-house show will be live streamed all day on The Big M's Facebook page and YouTube channel.

The Racetrack Television Network (rtn.tv) will offer the Meadowlands' in-house presentation free from playmeadowlands.com on Hambletonian Day.

The Television Games Network (tvg.com) will be onsite with commentary and showing the races live. TVG is one of the most popular Advance-Deposit Wagering (ADW) sites in the world.

The Hambletonian Oaks tops the undercard and has a post time of 4:48 p.m. That event will be shown as part of Fox Sports 2's (FS2) "America's Day at the Races" show, highlighting the thoroughbred action from Saratoga on Whitney Day, which showcases one of the best cards of the season in that sport. Post time for the Whitney is 5:48 p.m. Meadowlands' races will be featured between 12:30 p.m. and 5 p.m. on the telecast.

The CBS Sports Network (CBSSN) is doing a Hambletonian retrospective and 2022 recap on Sunday, Aug. 21, from 5:30 p.m.-6:30 p.m.

The Central Ontario Standardbred Association (COSA-TV) will have race day coverage from 3 p.m.-7:15 p.m. but will take a break for 45 minutes, starting at 5:15 p.m., during which time they will show the Big M simulcast feed.

DEEP POOLS: Management at The Big M is upping its game for the big day, increasing its guaranteed pools from the usual \$100,000 to \$350,000. The first race 20-cent Pick-6 is guaranteed at \$50,000; the third race 20-cent Pick-5 has a \$75,000 promise; the Early 50-cent Pick-4 that starts with race eight is guaranteed to be \$100,000, while the Late Pick-4 – which begins in the 12th race – is guaranteed at \$125,000.

The Late Pick-4 is one the fans are sure to love. It begins with the Hambletonian Oaks, ends with the Hambletonian, and has the Jim Doherty Memorial and John Cashman Memorial sandwiched in between.

The Late 20-cent Pick-6 will start in the 10th race and conclude with the Hambletonian. That wager, as well as the Late 50-cent Pick-4 and 20-cent Survivor Pick-7 (which begins in race five), has a mandatory payout.

LET ME TELL YOU A STORY: Some of the major Hambletonian Day story lines include:

• Is this one for the girls? Jiggy Jog S and Joviality S finished first and third, respectively, in the second Hambletonian elimination last week. Can one of them join Ramona Hill and Atlanta and become only the third filly in recent history to take home harness racing's greatest prize?

- Will the clock get rocked? The Meadowlands played host to the historic 1:45.4 mile put up by Bulldog Hanover in the William Haughton Memorial on Meadowlands Pace Night, July 16. With the Bulldog away, can his mark be lowered in the Sam McKee Memorial? One horse who has shown he can go big miles is Rockyroad Hanover, who won a division of the Roll With Joe on July 2 in 1:46.2, the same night Bulldog went 1:46. "Bulldog's 1:45.4 mile came at 9:55 p.m." said Settlemoir. "We all know that historically, the track is faster during the day. If we get ideal conditions, you could see history again."

Wallin fulfills childhood dream with Hambletonian appearance

Fourteen years ago, Lucas Wallin watched in wonderment at The Meadowlands as Ray Schnittker's Deweycheatumnhowe won the Hambletonian.

"That was the first Hambo I saw here," the Swede said. "After that, I said that one day I would move here and try to be in it. So, it's pretty cool."

Cool because at age 29, "one day" has arrived for the trainer, whose colt Rebuff is the 9-5 morning line favorite in Saturday's \$1 million Hambletonian, the sport's premier event for 3-year-old trotters, at The Big M. Tim Tetrick drove Rebuff to victory in his Hambletonian elimination last week by 1-1/4 lengths over Fast As The Wind in 1:52.2.

"I'm very happy with him," Wallin said. "He came out of the race good, too. As we've been through all these races, we have been very confident, and it feels like he just gets better and better. I think he showed that (in his elim) as well. I cannot be happier with him than I am right now. That's a great feeling this week."

Rebuff is owned by Kjell Magne Andersen, Pieter Delis and Wallin. He won last year's Breeders Crown for 2-year-old male trotters, has seven victories in 14 lifetime starts and \$573,670 in purses. He brings a six-race win streak, dating back to last October, into Saturday's final. Tetrick won the 2012 Hambletonian with Market Share.

Wallin has attachments to several folks at this year's race, either directly or through the sands of time.

He and wife Mikaela are expecting their first child in November and Mikaela takes care of Joviality S, a filly who is the race's second choice behind Rebuff, for her brother Marcus Melander. Joviality S is one of three Melander horses in the final. Ironically, Schnittker returns to the Hambletonian final (with Dan Patch Award-winner King Of The North) for just the second time since 2008, when a 15-year-old Lucas watched him win it all and started fantasizing about the first Saturday of August in East Rutherford, N.J.

This is not Wallin's first participating role in the Hambletonian. Last year, he drove Cuatro De Julio to a seventh-place finish. But it is the first horse he has trained that has made it to the final of the classic race.

"It means everything," Wallin said. "It's the first horse we tried to qualify for the Hambo, so of course it was good to make it to the final. Whatever happens, happens. We just have to work even harder if we don't work it out on Saturday. But it's a dream come true."

Lucas began driving ponies at age 8 in Sweden and soon began helping at his uncle Joakim Wallin's barn. After moving to America, he worked at Ake Svanstedt's stable from 2014 to 2016.

Svanstedt, who won the Hambletonian last year with Captain Corey and in 2017 with Perfect Spirit, has filly Jiggy Jog S in this year's final. She won the other elimination last week and is 4-1.

"I had a really good time (working for Svanstedt)," Wallan said. "I had a lot of responsibility and he let me drive a lot of horses. Working beside Ake is a huge thing. If you're interested and willing to learn, he's the right guy to be beside. You couldn't have a better trainer to work for."

But Wallin couldn't resist working for himself. He opened his own stable at age 23 and since then has won 148 races and \$3.5 million. He set a career high for purses last year with \$1.06 million.

"I wasn't too sure when I was going to be a trainer," Lucas said. "I just had a feeling I wanted to be on my own and try it out. I started with one horse that I bought at the mixed sale at The Meadowlands. Then I got one more and one more. Then I had four horses and we did okay. Each year, we just got better and better."

Wallin is quick to acknowledge that much of his success comes from being entrusted with talented animals.

"Without good horses, you are nothing," he said. "I have really good owners. That's the whole thing. You can work your (butt) off, but if you don't get the chance with good horses, you will not do good. I'm very thankful. It's probably tough to let a young guy from Sweden start on his own in another country. I'm very thankful for the guys that started with me."

After a six-year climb, Wallin is just enjoying the atmosphere of Hambletonian week.

"It's nice," he said. "A lot of people ask if I'm nervous and if there is pressure. On Saturday, of course I'll be more nervous, but right now it's just a normal week. I feel very confident in the horse, and (Tim Tetrick) and myself and the whole team around me. We have done whatever we can do, and he is going into the race in top shape. So, we're going to try to have some fun.

"Tim has done a tremendous job with him. We usually don't talk about tactics; I leave it up to him and then we can chit-chat a little bit. Before the Stanley Dancer, we said that if we had a chance, we would like to try him on the lead, so we tried that before the Hambo elimination. Otherwise, he does whatever he wants."

It is only the fourth start of the year for Rebuff and while some observers have been surprised by the small sample size, Wallin said it's all according to plan.

"I heard a lot of questions about what we did with him," he said. "He raced plenty of times as a 2-year-old, and he's a nice-sized

horse and pretty light and good gaited. We figured he probably didn't need so many starts to get him in shape. So far, the plan has been working out pretty perfect.

"It's different from horse to horse. But we've been very confident about it. It's one thing if we raced only three or four times last year, but he raced 11 times. We've been very confident since day one and it just gets higher and higher. We set up training for him to get better and better for each race."

Although he is a rookie trainer when it comes to the Hambletonian, Wallin is bringing a horse to the \$500,000 Hambletonian Oaks final for the fourth time with Manon, who is 8-1. He is one of five trainers this year with at least one horse in both the Hambletonian and Oaks.

Racing begins at noon (EDT) Saturday for the stakes-filled Hambletonian Day card. Watch from 12:30-5 p.m. on Fox Sports 2 (FS2) with coverage including the \$500,000 Hambletonian Oaks at 4:48 p.m. Watch from 6-7 p.m. on Fox Sports 1 (FS1) with coverage including the \$1 million Hambletonian at 6:35 p.m. For free TrackMaster programs of every Meadowlands card, visit the track's website here.

John Hayes stepping down as chair of Ontario Racing



The COVID-19 pandemic posed tremendous challenges to the horse racing industry, and OR through assistance from its government partners and extraordinary effort from the industry, came together to support horsepeople and equine athletes alike. Hayes' leadership was instrumental in the solutions that OR developed and executed.

"John is definitely a consensus builder. He can be very influential, because in his own quiet and dignified way he makes his point without pressure to the person he is speaking to," said Sue Leslie, Ontario Racing Board Member and president of the Horsemen's Benevolent Protective Association of Ontario. "John has a lot of class, and he has led with dignity. When you have class and dignity at the top, it sets the tone, and everyone follows. Ontario Racing will miss him, and his leadership."

While the Long-Term Funding Agreement and the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic were the largest items on OR's agenda the last four years, Hayes' leadership also touched the work the organization has done with breeding programs, equine welfare, and aftercare. The success of these efforts is a testament to his dedication to helping all facets of the horse racing industry.

"John was always looking for the betterment of each sector of the industry, whether that be quarter horse, thoroughbred, or standardbred, and the groups within those sectors," said Walter Parkinson, Ontario Racing Board Member, and president of the Standardbred Breeders of Ontario Association. "His dedication, knowledge, and passion for Ontario's horse racing and breeding industry is unquestionable. The industry as a whole benefited greatly from his time at Ontario Racing."

A lifelong fan of the sport, Hayes will continue to stay involved in the industry as an owner. He is looking forward to seeing OR's next Independent Chair lead the organization and the horse racing industry writ large as it continues to build a healthy and thriving industry in the province of Ontario.

"I look forward to remaining involved in the horse racing industry in Ontario," said Hayes. "Thanks to our work the past four years, we are on a strong path, and I look forward to seeing the future successes of the industry."

Human Cocktail sets Batavia track record in NYSS action

The New York Sire Stakes made their third visit to Batavia Downs on Wednesday night (Aug. 3) and featured the 2-year-old pacing colts and geldings who competed for a total of \$107,000 in purses. The highlight of the night was when **Human Cocktail** (Huntsville—Losta Matzah) rallied late to win the second \$53,500 division in 1:53.3 and set a new Batavia Downs track record for 2-year-old pacing colts.

Kid From The Bronx (Mark Macdonald) left hard and led by a gapped three length margin through panels of :27.1 and :55.3 with Human Cocktail (Jim Morrill Jr.) and Its A Me Mario (Jason Bartlett) trying to keep pace. Moving past five-eighths Its A Me Mario came with a rush and took the lead from Kid From The Bronx at three-quarters but the race was far from won.

Around the last turn Kid From The Bronx fought back and as the two were stacked up, forced Human Cocktail to go three-wide

heading into the stretch. As Kid From The Bronx and Its A Me Mario began to tire, Human Cocktail rolled past them both in the middle of the track and pulled away to a ½ length victory over the fast closing Thunder Hunter Joe (Austin Siegleman) in 1:53.3, which was also a new lifetime mark.

After moving up from Excel "A" action, it was the first NYSS win for Human Cocktail (\$3.90) and owner Stephen Demeter, who also bred the winner along with Blue Chip Bloodstock and Daniel Zucker. Gareth Dowse trains the colt.

Earlier there was a major upset in the first \$53,500 split as **Huntinthelastdolar** (Huntsville—Eighthunrddolarbill) upended the 1-9 favorite American Fling with a strong stretch finish.

American Fling (Jason Bartlett) went right to the front while Huntinthelastdolar (Doug McNair) settled in second for a perfect trip. American Fling went :27.4 and :58.3 on top by three lengths at the half where Johnny Sack (Mark Macdonald) pulled first-over and tried to move into contention.

With the added pressure from the outside American Fling sped up the third panel and Huntinthelastdolar started gapping in the hole, but that all changed again in the last turn. Johnny Sack began to fade and Huntinthelastdolar was tight again on American Fling's back. When the passing lane opened, McNair dipped into it with Huntinthelastdolar and paced away from the tiring American Fling to win by 1-1/2 lengths in a lifetime best 1:55 1.

It was the first lifetime start and NYSS victory by Huntinthelastdolar (\$19.20) for his owners Steve Heimbecker and Gregg McNair, who also trains the colt. Crawford Farms bred Huntinthelastdolar.



Earthwindfire, Hunting Season win NYSS sophomore pacing filly events at Yonkers

Two-year-old pacing fillies duked it out in New York Sire Stakes contests on Tuesday night (Aug. 2) at Yonkers Raceway, and **Earthwindfire** and **Hunting Season** would win the pair of \$75,900 top-level splits.

Vivians Dream (Jordan Stratton) came into the first division with a four-for-four record and led through fractions of :27.3, :57.1 and 1:26.3, but Earthwindfire (Jack Pelling) vacated the pocket in the last turn, rallied in the lane, and was able to get by Vivians Dream in time to win by a neck in 1:54, a lifetime-best clocking. Alabama Hannah (Jason Bartlett) was the third-place finisher.

Earthwindfire is an American Ideal filly trained by Brett Pelling for owners Mel Segal, Kentuckiana Racing Stable, and Tulip Racing. A \$100,000 purchase at the 2021 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale, Earthwindfire has two wins and a second in three outings and has now banked \$78,075. She paid \$4.40 to win as the second choice and was atop a \$5.50 exacta and a \$12.40 trifecta. Bred by Dr. Stephen Dey III, Earthwindfire is out of the Bettor's Delight mare Road Bet [1:52, \$380,315], making Earthwindfire a half-sister to Cattlewash [1:46.4, \$1,314,787] and to Niki Hill [1:50.2, \$904,556].

In the second flight Hunting Season (Mark MacDonald) went to the top from the pole position and hit the quarter in :27.4, the half in :57.4, and the three-quarters in 1:27. Rock My Socks (Bartlett) advanced first-over out of fourth in the third quarter but stalled out in second and then was no match for Hunting Season in the stretch, as the pace-setter pulled away to prevail by a length and a half in 1:55. Rock My Socks came home as the runner-up and pocket-sitter Dame (Luke Hanners) got third.

A daughter of Huntsville—That's How We Roll, Hunting Season was bred and is owned by trainer Ray Schnittker in partnership with Mary Kinsey-Arnold and Steven Arnold. Hunting Season picked up her third victory in her sixth start, and she has now earned \$97,890. She returned \$3.00 to win as the 1-2 favorite and keyed a \$5.00 exacta and an \$11.40 trifecta.





Stratton tallied with **B On The Hunt**, a daughter of Huntsville—Twin B Elite bred by Kathryn Weed & M.K. Weed, trained by his brother Cory, and owned by Our Three Sons Stable LLC. and Stratton Stable Inc. in 1:56.3, and with Doing Marvelous, a Bolt The Duer—Marvalous Joy filly bred by Winbak Farm, owned by Frank Chick, and trained by Cory Mumford in 1:56.1.

Lady Jericho, a daughter of Dude's The Man—Taylorlane Diva bred by Gary Smith, owned by Jennifer Safford, and trained by John Berger, won the first New York Excelsior "A" section in 1:55.3 with Austin Siegelman driving, and Rec Time, a Huntsville—Ms Malicious filly bred by Fair Winds Farm, Mark Mullen, and Steve Jones, owned by D Racing Stable Inc. and Jason O'Sullivan, and trained by Deborah Daguet, completed the New York Excelsior "A" Series winners with a 1:55.1 mile for driver Jason Bartlett.

One non-wagering \$6,700 New York Excelsior "B" Series race also took place, and **Cannery Row**, a daughter of American Ideal—My Monterey bred and owned by Crawford Farms, tallied in 1:57.1 for Bartlett and trainer Tony Alagna.

Yonkers will welcome the New York Sire Stakes circuit back to Westchester next Tuesday night (Aug. 9) as the 3-year-old pacing colts and geldings will compete in their sixth out of seven preliminary rounds.



The Meadows, MSOA honor Brady Brown for career win 1,000

Hollywood Casino at The Meadows and the Meadows Standardbred Owners Association on Wednesday (Aug. 3) honored driver Brady Brown, who collected career win 1,000 Monday at the Clearfield County (PA) Fair.

"It's always been a big dream of mine to get this," Brown said. "It's a big accomplishment to me. I always thought about it and, sure enough, here I am."

Brown, 29, is a native of Slippery Rock, Butler County, about 70 miles north of The Meadows, and still resides there. He grew up around harness racing, as his grandfather, Robert Brown, his father, Terry Brown, and Terry's friend Bean Callahan together owned Standardbreds that they campaigned from their base at the Butler County Fairgrounds.

"I took every chance I could get to go to the barns," Brown recalls. "I started at the bottom, doing the stalls. My grandfather was a homicide detective, and my father was a police officer in Slippery Rock. If I hadn't gone for the horses, I would have been a police officer. But I got the bug."

While he dropped out of high school to pursue a driving career, his sister, Ashley Brown, took a parallel path to racing, opting to get her nursing degree before settling into the sport as a trainer. She now operates a Meadows-based stable with her husband, trainer/driver Chris Shaw.

At the fairgrounds, young Brady was befriended by trainer Steve Schoeffel, who was a presence at both Pennsylvania's pari-mutuel tracks and the PA Fairs circuit. It was Schoeffel who gave Brown his biggest career boost, naming him on many of his fairs performers — but all in due time.

"That relationship is very important to me," Brown says. "Steve gave me my first drive when I was 16, but he didn't give me the whole works. He had a barnful of 25, and I drove one horse for him. He definitely made me earn it. That's the best way to learn."

Fittingly, Brown's milestone win came with Blue Ashes, a Schoeffel trainee.

Once Brown earned his spurs at the fairs and began picking up more pari-mutuel drives, he was still something of a mystery to local players, who often sent him off at monstrous odds. He brought home a steady stream of those long shots, earning him the nickname "Downtown Brady Brown." He likes that sobriquet.

"Just about everybody I see calls me that," he said. "I still have those long shots. They're not always 3-5."

This season, Brown ranks fifth (by wins) among all Meadows drivers. During his career, his mounts have earned more than \$9.6 million in purses.

Among Brown's favorite horses through the years has been the Schoeffel-trained Royalty Has Arrived; they all teamed to win a PA Fairs championship in 2015 when Royalty Has Arrived, now 10 and still competing, was 3.

"That horse made me look good," Brown says. "Age has gotten to him a little bit. He's not quite the caliber of horse that he was, but he's still a gutsy horse."

Brown doesn't anticipate making any major changes for the immediate future.

"I go day by day," he says. "I don't get too crazy looking ahead. If I can keep doing what I'm doing right now, I'm just fine with that."

On Wednesday at The Meadows, Brown kept doing what he's been doing, recording career wins 1,002 and 1,003.
