Breaking down Hambletonian Day 2019

Trainer Marcus Melander may not have won the Hambletonian, but he won the most money on the day — \$839,947.50 in purses on the day. He won the Jim Doherty, both Hambletonian elims, was second, third and fifth in the Hambletonian final, fourth in the Hambletonian Oaks, fifth in the Cashman, fourth in a Hambletonian elim, and 2-3-4 in the Peter Haughton.

However, it was 13 years since the last time a trainer won both Hambletonian eliminations, but not the final. Trond Smedshammer did it with Here Comes Herbie in 2006 and Mr Pine Chip, but Glidemaster won the final and neither winner in the elimination got any money in the final.

Marcus Melander won his first Hambletonian elim back in 2017 with Enterprise who was third in the final.



Only in America

The only U.S-born trainer to make the Hambletonian final was Tony Alagna with Pilot Discretion, who failed to get a check.

The only U.S-born trainer to make the Hambletonian Oaks was Ron Burke, who was eighth with Sonnet Grace.

Zeron U.S.-born trainers were in the 2019 Elitlopp, but of the 88 trotters on the Hambletonian Day card (counting the 10 in the Hambletonian final as separate — 78 trotters and 88 starters), 40 were trained by a conditioner born in Sweden.


Oh, Canada

The following all participated on the day that a Canadian driver and trainer won both the Hambletonian Oaks and the Hambletonian — Rene and Simon Allard in the Oaks and Luc Blais and Bob McClure in the Hambletonian. Jim Campbell was the Peter Haughton and Cashman winner. Fellow Canadians Yannick Gingras won the Vincennes, Casie Coleman was third with reigning HOY McWicked in the Sam

McKee Memorial, Scott Zeron won the Cane Pace. Daniel Dube, John Bax and Benoit Baillargeon were also in action.

Peter Haughton jinx continues

In 2018, Don't Let'em and Green Manalishis S were 1-2 in the Peter Haughton. In the Hambletonian final, Don't Let'em made a break and finished last and Green Manalishi S was fifth.

Only two horses have won both the Peter Haughton and the Hambletonian in 38 years: Donato Hanover 2006-2007 and Muscle Hill 2008-2009.

The last time a Peter Haughton runner-up won the Hambletonian the following year was Mack Lobell in 1987.

Muscle Hill's day - again!

Progeny of Muscle Hill has now won the Hambletonian or the Oaks six times in his first six crops. Muscle Hill-with four winners on Saturday and a 1-2-3 finish in the Jim Doherty, was the only trotting sire to win more than once.

Captaintreacherous doubled up on the pacing side. Make it four straight Oaks wins for Muscle Hill. When Dovescry followed Manchego who followed Ariana G who followed All The Time.

Odds are... odds on

There were nine odds-on winners among the 11 winning favorites for the day.

Quartet to remember

The last four Horses of the Year all went down to defeat on Hambletonian Day:

In 2015, Wiggle It Jiggleit was fourth in the Cane Pace.


In 2016, Always B Miki was fourth in the U.S. Pacing Championship.

In 2017, Hannelore Hanover was fourth in the Steele Memorial.

In 2018, McWicked was second in the Sam McKee Memorial.

By a neck

The closest margin of the 16 contests was also the most popular one — a neck. Four winners won by that margin: Green Manalishi S in Hambletonian elim, Tall Drink Hanover in the Shady Daisy, Forbidden Trade in the Hambletonian final and Captain Crunch in the Cane Pace.



Harness Racing Update

Kadabra

Six years ago, Kadabra's daughter Bee A Magician won the Oaks, ran the table on the year (17-for-17) and was voted HOY. That was also the last time a horse has won on Hambletonian Day and was named HOY. This year, Forbidden Trade is a son of Kadabra, who himself was not Hambletonian eligible back in 2002 en route to the division title.

Did you know??

That Forbidden Trade has more wins (12) than Greenshoe has starts (11)?

Record day

Ten of the 24 Meadowlands track records were set on a Hambletonian Day card.

First time for everything

Sixteen years after his Hambletonian debut, Brian Sears finished second for the very first time.

Manchego a modern day Moni Maker?

Manchego has now won on Hambletonian Day at 2, 3 and 4-with a pair of 1:50 wins in the Oaks then the Steele Memorial. Moni Maker was an incredible 5-for-5 on Hambletonian Day, winning twice in 1996 in the Oaks, then again in the Nat Ray (Cashman) in 1997, 1998 and 2000. She missed in 1999 due to heart trouble. Her 2000 Nat Ray win was her last Meadowlands start and her lifetime mark of 1:52.1.

Youth served?

When Bob McClure, 28, won the Hambletonian, it was the fifth time a driver under 30 to accomplished this. Scott Zeron won at 27 and 29, Tommy Haughton at 25 and Harry Harvey at 29 way back in 1953.

Twenty-seven-year-old trainer Marcus Melander was 2-3-5 in the Hambletonian.

Twice a better than 50-1 shot hit the board during Saturday's Hambletonian Day card at the Meadowlands:

In the second race, 53-1 shot Mach N Cheese won for driver Simon Allard.

In the 15th race, 94-1 shot Semi Tough was third with Matt Kakaley.

Father-son duos dominate Battles on Industry Day

The father-son teams of Carl and Jody Jamieson and Gregg and Doug McNair won the Battle of Waterloo and Battle of the Belles, respectively, Monday at Grand River Raceway.

Grand River Raceway marked its 29th annual Industry Day celebration on Monday (Aug. 5). The afternoon featured 11 races totaling \$540,850 in purses, including the track's feature dashes, the Battle Of Waterloo and Battle Of The

Belles, both of which were broadcast live (and are still available for viewing) on **HRU's Facebook page** thanks to the Central Ontario Standardbred Association (COSA).

It was a homecoming of sorts for two families who have previously dominated these jewel races in the Elora, ON track's marquee event.

22nd annual Battle Of Waterloo

Nine rookie 2-year-old pacing colts vied for glory in the 22nd edition of the \$239,000 Battle Of Waterloo.

Trainer Carl Jamieson and his son, driver Jody Jamieson,

teamed up to win with Sports Obsession, their 7-1 starter from post five.

Jamieson maneuvered traffic trouble past the halfway marker when Bettorbuckleup and Beach Blanket Book hooked wheels and were taken out of contention.

Soon after, the winning pair cleared to the lead and remained on top to clinch the win. The 1:54 score was the Sportswriter son's second career win in five starts. Betting favourite Wind Blown with J Harris was second for trainer Teesha Symes. Aneto with Bob McClure rounded out the top

three.

Carl Jamieson co-owns Sports Obsession with George Harrison.

"I told everyone that the horse had a good shot. We just needed a little luck," Carl said.

Carl Jamieson trained and drove the first-ever Battle Of Waterloo winner Distinctiv Skeeter in 1998. He also piloted and trained CT Rocket in 2000 and went on to win three more editions with son Jody in the bike in 2002, 2004 and

2006. Neither has won the race since.

"Dad and I did it again," Jody Jamieson said, beaming. "I think it was a special omen today, us teaming up again in the Battle of Waterloo after those victories in the past."

11th annual Battle Of The Belles

A field of talented 2-year-old pacing fillies contested the 11th edition of the \$157,500 Battle Of The Belles.

Doug McNair and Karma Seelster capitalized on early action to capture the win at 27-1 in 1:54.4, which matches the stake record set by Play The Bell in 2017. Karma Seelster scored her maiden win in her elimination division last week but drew the outside starting post (#8) in the final.

She took to the top as heavy-favorite Alicorn (post four) and Louis Philippe Roy made a break at the first quarter. Alicorn matched the divisional track record in her elimination win last week in 1:54.2. She also holds an OSS speed record earned earlier this year.

After her miscue, Roy quickly regrouped Alicorn and she came on strong to finish second for trainer Chantal Mitchell. Temagami Seelster and J Harris were third.

This was the second Battle Of The Belles title for the father-son duo of driver Doug McNair and trainer Gregg McNair, both of Guelph, ON. The pair won the 2013 edition with Lady Shadow. They also paired up to win the Batlle Of Waterloo in 2008, 2013 and 2015.

"I haven't been in the winner's circle for a while for one of these races," said Doug McNair. "I remember when I was 18 standing here. Time flies. It feels pretty good to be here today. And nice to get one for Keith (Waples)."

Hall Of Fame horseman Keith Waples co-owns the Sportswriter filly with his wife Eileen and their daughter Karen Hauver. Karma Seelster was a \$127,000 yearling purchase in 2018 at the London Select Sale.

"We had a little trouble with her gait this winter (in Florida) but she has really come along since we've been back in Ontario," said Gregg McNair. "It's great to win at Grand River Raceway. It's our home track and we're here quite a bit in the spring training these horses down and I really like it here," he said.

Undercard

The Industry Day undercard included five divisions of Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) for 3-year-old colt pacers.

Division leader Sugartown sweetened his hold on the year-end Grassroots title. The Sportswriter son held off Fast N First (James MacDonald) to win his third sophomore OSS

race (and sixth season win) by a neck in 1:53.1 with Louis Philippe Roy for trainer Richard Moreau.

That 1:53.1 clocking was the quickest of OSS action on Industry Day and matched the first division of the day when Travis Cullen steered Dreamfair Moxy to his sixth career win for owner John Lamers and trainer Jodie Cullen.

The final division featured HP Napoleon in his fourth consecutive win from nine starts this season. Mario Baillargeon drove the Big Jim gelding for brother Ben Baillargeon to a three-quarter-length finish in 1:54.3.

The quickest mile of the afternoon went to Ghost Dance in the Preferred pace (Race 9). Bob McClure piloted the Nick Gallucci student to a front-end win by 13 lengths in 1:51.1 for owner Millar Farms. It was the first win of the season for the four-year-old gelding. He has banked \$166,000 in career earnings.

Record Handle

Monday's handle of \$488,696 is a new Industry Day record, besting the previous record of \$481,239 set in 2016.

Top sophomores set to clash in \$400,000 Carl Milstein Memorial

The race is on tap Saturday at MGM Northfield Park.

Bettor's Wish has been named the 5-2 morning line favorite by Northfield's executive vice-president of racing and simulcasting, Dave Bianconi, in Saturday's \$400,000 Carl Milstein Memorial. The top money-earner headlines an accomplished field of eight in Northfield Park's premier event. The Milstein is a 3-year-old open by invitation only. The featured event is slated as race 10 on a 16-race program and carries a 6 p.m. first-race post time, with the main event slated for approximately 9:30 p.m.

Bettor's Wish is the winner of this year's \$300,000 Art Rooney Memorial at Yonkers. He has won five of eight races this year. His three losses have been runner-up finishes in the \$1 million North America Cup, \$682,650 Meadowlands Pace and the \$285,362 Cane Pace. The Chris Ryder trainee has banked \$624,544 in purses this year and drew post-3. Bettor's Wish is owned by the partnership of Chris Ryder,

Bella Racing, Fair Island Form and Bettors Wish Partners. They will use Dexter Dunn, who hails from New Zealand and has been a driving force since coming to the United States.

Century Farroh drew post-2 and is the 7-2 second choice. He ventures south of the border for the first time in his career on the heels of a 4-race win streak. This top Ontario Sires Stakes performer has won eight of nine races this year, and has earned \$241,959 for owner Ratchford Stable of Nova Scotia. Trainer Dr. Ian Moore listed Harness Racing Hall of Famer David Miller to drive.

Workin Ona Mystery drew post five and is the 4-1 third choice. He is fresh off a 1:51.1 (last quarter :25.3) qualifier at Hoosier Park. He has not missed the board this year and has three wins in six races, including third place finishes in the North America Cup and Meadowlands Pace. Brian Brown trains this colt at the historic Fairgrounds in Delaware, OH for owners Diamond Creek Racing, Stambaugh Leeman Stable (Wauseon, OH), Alan Keith (Johnstown, OH) and Wingfield Brothers LLC (Kenton, OH). Workin Ona Mystery has \$248,489 in earnings this year and will be driven by racing superstar Tim Tetrick.

The race is named in honor of Carl Milstein, who owned Northfield Park from 1984 until his death in 1999. The Milstein family operated Northfield Park until July, 2018 when MGM Growth Properties purchased the racetrack from Milstein Entertainment, LLC.

In 1972, the senior Milstein, a Cleveland builder and real estate developer, headed a group of several partners, including George Steinbrenner, which purchased Northfield Park. They leased the facility to other operators through the early 1980s. The track lost significant amounts of money during that period before Milstein took full ownership and control. In late 1984 he successfully applied to the Ohio State Racing Commission for the necessary licenses and, beginning in January 1985, conducted permanent race meetings at Northfield of between 212 and 238 days every year.

Milstein was the driving force behind a resurgence of the beleaguered track, which ascended to among harness racing's top tracks in attendance and handle. He was an innovator in promotions and advertising and successfully led the track into the era of simulcast racing.

Exciting undercard

This year's Milstein Memorial program carries total purses in excess of \$750,000.

The 16-race program includes the \$50,000 Myron Charna

Workin Ona Mystery (Tim Tetrick, winning their North America Cup elimination) will start from post 5 in the Milstein.

President's Pace, a race for 4-year-old and up Ohio sired pacers (by invitation only), three \$40,000 divisions of Ohio Sires Stakes for 3-year-old colt trotters, two \$50,000 divisions of Ohio Sires Stakes for 3-year-old filly pacers, as well as two \$15,000 Open events.

A \$20,000 Pick 4 guaranteed pool started in race seven and consists of a \$40,000 OSS, the Charna, the Open Pace and the Milstein. Another Pick 4 begins in race 11 and offers a \$10,000 guaranteed pool.

In addition to superior racing action, Milstein Night will also offer guests a sumptuous spread in Lady Luck's clubhouse dining room. The dinner buffet, inspired by MGM Northfield Park Executive Chef Chris Poplin, is specially priced at \$21.95. Limited clubhouse seating remains; call 330.467.4101 for reservations.

Guests who want to be down close to all the racing action can gather on the grandstand apron and enjoy live music and food trucks from 6 to 9 p.m. Register for the Charna/Milstein Handicapping Double Contest, play Plinko from 6:30 to 7:30PM and spin the Prize Wheel 8:30 to 9:30 p.m. Admission and parking are always free at Northfield Park.

Hambletonian winners Bob McClure and Forbidden Trade are Canadian treasures

One year after the Kawhi Leonard trade set the Toronto Raptors on the path toward an NBA Championship, another "trade" gave the nation of Canada an additional huge triumph in 2019.

Forbidden Trade, a trotter owned by Quebec's Determination Stables, pulled off a shocking 15-1 upset in the \$1 million Hambletonian at the Meadowlands on Saturday. Much like the Raptors slaying of the two-time defending champion Golden State Warriors, prohibitive Hambletonian favorite Greenshoe – a 1-5 public-choice – tasted defeat after a determined effort from Forbidden Trade, who made his 28-year-old driver Bob McClure a Hambletonian winner in his first attempt in the sport's biggest event.

McClure likened his victory to the Raptors' recent NBA victory.

"I absolutely love the Raptors," said McClure. "The entire nation was so proud and I think even a lot of Americans were cheering for (the Raptors), probably because we were the underdog and everybody loves an underdog."

Six weeks later, as a rank outsider, McClure himself got the opportunity to embrace and capitalize on the underdog role. He claims that "flying under the radar" at this year's trotting classic was an advantage that relieved him of pressure.

"The most pressure I had was on Twitter," said McClure. "For the last week or two, it's been hashtag 'go Canada go'. I felt like it was us against the U.S."

Prior to Saturday, McClure and Forbidden Trade's only other trip to the Meadowlands was a seventh-place finish in an elimination for last year's Valley Victory on Nov. 17, the same day Leonard sat out of a game against the Chicago Bulls to rest.

Rest also proved to be a stoppage in McClure's journey to the winner's circle, but under less than ideal circumstances. During a qualifier at Woodbine Mohawk Park in late April, a chain reaction accident was triggered when a competing horse stepped on the wheel of another, spilling multiple drivers out of their sulkies and onto the track.

One of those drivers was McClure, who sustained a broken pelvis. The accident put McClure out of racing for an extended period of time in which he was restrained to almost no movement throughout the day.

"I've never experienced anything like (that), and in our industry there's a lot of it," said McClure. "I made sure I didn't move. I was going to the hyperbolic chamber four times a week. I was going to physiotherapy four times a week and just laying down and resting as much as I could. I tried not to watch the races, because it just made me depressed."

McClure spent six weeks on the sidelines, and it was time that McClure was able to fully devote to family. McClure's toddler son

became the beneficiary of a month and a half of his injured father being rooted firmly at home for maximum bonding time.

"From the time he was born, I've been able to spend seven days a week with him, so I'm really lucky that way," said McClure. "The only difference was, (after I got hurt) I was able to spend nights with him and I was able to watch him go to sleep every night. It was nice family time, but my wife was gonna kill me if I stayed home any longer."

The injury that gave McClure that time with his 3-year-old son proved to only be a temporary roadblock in his Hambletonian journey. He returned to the track one day after the Raptors went up 3-2 over the Milwaukee Bucks in the NBA's Eastern Conference Finals.

The team of McClure and Forbidden Trade found themselves on an unstoppable run in the wake of his return, winning four races in a row going into the Hambletonian, where they pulled off the big surprise to join Kawhi Leonard and the Raptors as national heroes.

"Unfortunately, he's gone now," said McClure, alluding to Leonard's offseason, free agent signing with the Los Angeles Clippers. "But he brought the city and the country a title, so he owes us nothing."

Legendary NJ horseman's farm to be auctioned

The Colts Neck, NJ, horse farm founded by the late Hall of Famer Anthony T. Abbatiello, a leader in the growth of harness racing that propelled New Jersey to prominence in the sport for four decades, is to be sold at auction on site on Sept. 5.

Sale of the 64.3-acre property, reduced from its original 450 acres many years ago by a state takeover of land for a major state highway (Route 18), includes a house, two barns with horse or livestock stalls, a half-mile horse training track, an accessory building with three large garage-type bays, four ponds for fishing or irrigation.

The farm, a significant real estate part of shaping New Jersey harness racing history, is in close proximity to Freehold Raceway and convenient to Monmouth Park and The Meadowlands racetracks.

The prominent Max Spann real estate firm will conduct the auction at 11 a.m. on Sept. 5, with on-site property previews scheduled for Aug. 13 and 24 from 12 to 2 p.m.

Abbatiello, who died in October 2017, established the standardbred-training farm 65 years ago after his heroic service in the Korean War that earned him three Purple Hearts, two Bronze Stars and a nomination for the Silver Star, among numerous battle citations and honors.

Named Five Point Farm for the road on which it is located, Abbatiello brought his two younger brothers Carmine, who also is a Harness Racing Hall of Famer, and Matt with him to create one of the eventual focal points of New Jersey harness racing. Carmine, one of harness racing's premier drivers, was inducted in 1985. When Anthony was inducted nine years later, they became the first brother combination to be so honored.

Abbatiello, born and raised in Staten Island, NY, bought and founded the farm shortly after he returned from the war and worked briefly for the late Hall of Famer Stanley Dancer, whose Egyptian Acres farm was located nearby.

Abbatiello co-founded with Dancer the Standardbred Breeders and Owners Association of New Jersey, served as the group's president for nearly 30 years and was influential in the establishment of The Meadowlands and bringing the world famous Hambletonian race to that racetrack.
