Willinger lives his dream with long-awaited Fox Stake win

Forty-three years after vowing to one day win the Grand Circuit race at the Indiana State Fair, Andy Willinger was emotional after This Jk Rocks narrowly won the 98th edition.

Andy Willinger arrived at the Indiana State Fair in the summer of 1981 to campaign a pacing filly with his parents. He left that day aspiring to one day win the coveted Fox Stake. Wednesday afternoon (Aug. 7), 43 years removed from his first trip to Indianapolis, Willinger finally checked off that bucket list item when freshman This Jk Rocks narrowly won the 98th edition of the featured Grand Circuit race with a 1:52.2 effort.

“It was emotional as I walked out there,” said Willinger, who owns This Jk Rocks in partnership with Doug Overhiser and Engel

Stable of Il LLC. “I finally won the doggone thing. I wouldn’t have thought that 43 years later I would get to live my dream.”

Back in 1981, Willinger got his first taste of the Grand Circuit when his family journeyed from the Bluegrass of Kentucky to the Circle City as part of the ownership group behind young pacer Sconce. She would become a world champion at 2 and 3, racing second to the great Three Diamonds in the Jugette. On Fox day, however, she didn’t fare as well over the Indiana State Fairgrounds strip.

“It had rained so hard that morning that they scraped the track. She led to three quarters and her feet just got to stinging and she backed up through the field,” said Willinger, a resident of Louisville, KY. “We hung around and watched the Fox. It was such a cool race. Back then, the purse was \$160,000, \$170,000. I was a 21-year-old kid. I said, ‘Man, this is cool. This is like the Kentucky Derby, but for harness horses.’”

That day, the Fox Stake speed record was set twice. Temujin, driven by Clarence Martin, Sr., covered the mile in 1:54.4 to secure the first heat. That mark was lowered in the second heat by Icarus Lobell, who triumphed in 1:54.2. While Temujin broke stride in the second heat, he recovered to finish fourth to claim the overall prize as Icarus Lobell also broke stride in the first heat and finished last.

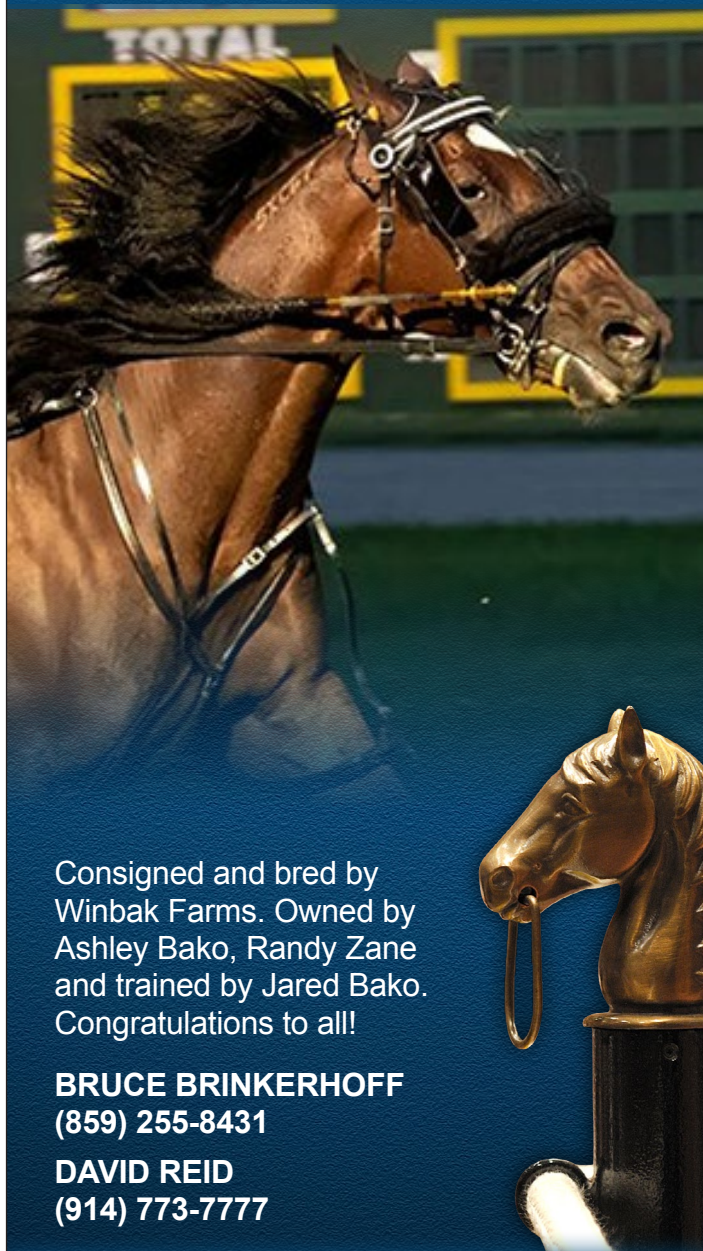
By his own admission, Willinger assumed he would have achieved the goal of winning the Fox Stake sooner. But the concentration of his racing interests didn’t always align with that objective. At one point, he focused more on buying fillies and racing them, emphasizing their residual value as broodmares when leaving the track. Within the last decade, he has also placed a higher priority on investing in the Indiana program. Trainer Erv Miller has increased his presence in the Hoosier State, and the long-time owner has followed suit. He likes the proximity and the convenience of being close enough to watch trackside as his horses race at the fair or Harrah’s Hoosier Park.

“It’s only been recently we’ve started buying more Indiana yearlings. Over the years we didn’t race there. The Fox was out

of the picture," Willinger said. "Being from Louisville, I like to watch my horses race, and I like to watch them live."

The Miller Stable's Indiana string train over the fairgrounds oval, and it played to their advantage Wednesday. Miller-trained trotters and pacers won five of the 11 Grand Circuit events. Willinger was a partner on three winners, and he owned pieces of 11 different entrants. In previous years, he has had no more than four entries on the Fox Stake program.

"It was a really good day," Willinger said. "They all, for the most part, raced well."

High Speed Swan was the first to put Willinger in the winner's circle. The Swan For All—Aunt Susie gelding captured the \$22,141 Hoosier Stake division for 2-year-old trotting colts by 4¼ lengths. Steered by Mike Oosting, the freshman stopped the clock in 1:58.2. Owned by Willinger, Anthony Lombardi and Engel Stable of IL LLC and bred by Victory Hill Farm, High Speed Swan is now two-for-two in 2024.

"In Florida, we knew he had some speed, but he needs to grow up," Willinger said. "If you look at him, you can tell he's got some filling out and growing to do. I think he'll be a better 3-year-old than he is a 2-year-old. Mike just came on and he trotted strong through the lane. He's going to be a factor the rest of the year, I think, in the sires stakes."

Jada Caroline nearly added another win, coming a head short to stablemate Plays In The Shade in the \$29,836 Horseman Stake for sophomore pacing fillies. Two races later, Skyway Masterpiece took control after the quarter and never looked back, claiming the \$27,022 Horseman division for 3-year-old pacing colts in a time of 1:54. The gelded son of Tellitlikeitis was bred by Kenny Slabach and is owned by Overhiser, Engel Stable of IL LLC and Willinger, this time racing under the banner of the Lava Java Stable.

"He wasn't mature enough to even think about racing in the Fox last season," Willinger said. "We left him in the Indiana Sires Stakes eligible races. He did win in [1]:49.4, so he has ability. He's just knocking at the door of being a competitive sires stakes horse."

and holds the 2-year-old and 3-year-old trotting speed records at the Indiana State Fairgrounds. Ponda Rocky finished third Wednesday in the Ralph Wilfong Memorial, circling the oval in 1:59.1.

"He had a couple issues getting ready, but now he's figured it out and he's gaining confidence," said Willinger. "He's not as tall as his brother, but he goes similar to Ponda Adventure. He's straighter. He's more correct than Ponda Adventure was. There are a lot of similarities, and I hope there continues to be."

In the day's \$39,874 feature, This Jk Rocks and Marcus Miller settled in second in the five-horse Fox Stake while stablemate

Gigi’s Dream cut the mile. Racing out of the last turn, Miller pulled on the right line and took aim at the leader. After quickly dispatching Gigi’s Dream, This Jk Rocks had to contend with a fast-closing Hopeyaliketheshow. The Jk Endofanera—This Peach Rocks gelding held on by a neck to claim his second win in five starts. Bred by Victory Hill Farm, his other victory came in Indiana Sires Stakes competition at Hoosier Park. Gigi’s Dream, also owned by Willinger in partnership, faded to fourth.

“This Jk Rocks, he’s a nice colt,” Willinger said. “He was good all winter, and we’re just blessed to have a good one at the right time to win the Fox. The few years we’ve had shots to race in it, they’re not ready to go, they’re not mature enough, they’ve got some knicks.”

While it was the owner’s first Fox Stake score, Erv Miller added his fourth as a conditioner. He previously won with Coach Stefanos (2022), Rockin Rusty (2017) and Sombaro Montae (2015). It was Marcus Miller’s first win as a driver.

Willinger is accustomed to seeing his horses perform well at the Indiana State Fair, but Wednesday was different. It was an event more than four decades in the making, and worth the wait. The Fox Stake no longer carries the clout it once did as a key event on the Grand Circuit calendar. It lacks an enticing purse in the now slots-fueled era. Those facts were irrelevant to an owner who had sought to claim victory in a race that captured his interest so long ago.

All hail the current 'Queen of Pacing'

Twin B Joe Fresh continued her winning ways on Hambletonian Day.

The current "Queen of Pacing," Twin B Joe Fresh cut through another stake like a hot knife in butter, easily winning the Lady Liberty at The Meadowlands in 1:48, which elicited a "Wow!" from Meadowlands' track announcer Ken Warkentin.

Off that impressive Hambletonian Day performance on Saturday (Aug. 3) over a top-notch field of mare pacers that included Sylvia Hanover, Silver Label and Grace Hill among others, Twin B Joe Fresh remains atop the Hambletonian Society/Breeders Crown Standardbred Poll for the fourth-straight week.

"It's a major compliment, really," said trainer Chris Ryder, who co-owns the mare with her driver Dexter Dunn, Peter Trebotica and Barry Spak.

Until recently, Dunn had no idea that the daughter of Roll With Joe—Fresh Breeze was so highly ranked.

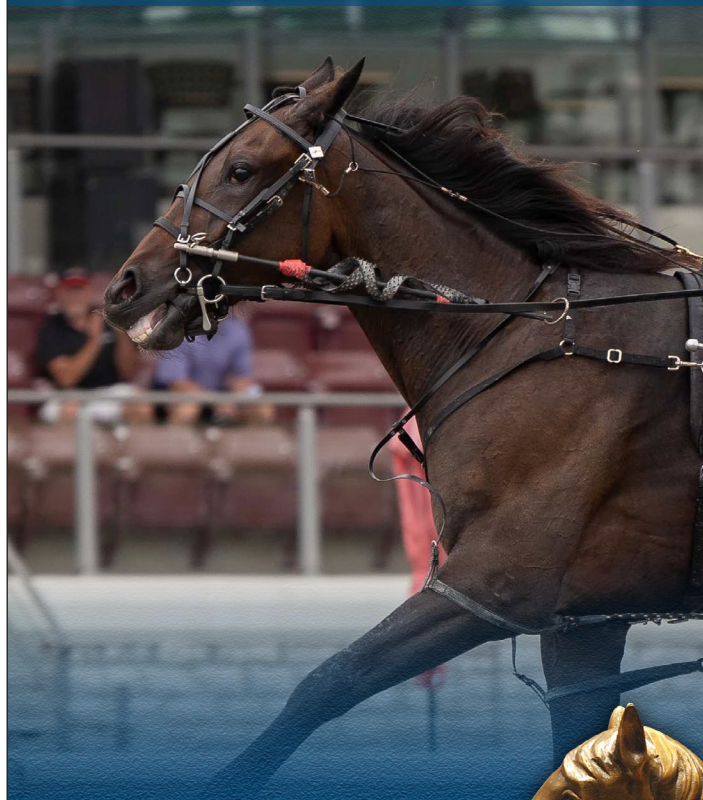

“Somebody mentioned it just the other day, last week,” Dunn said. “I said, ‘She's number one?’ They said, ‘Yeah, she's been number one for like two weeks.’ I didn't even realize.

“Well, she put on a good performance the other day, that's for sure.”

Also putting on a good performance on Hambletonian Day was Karl, who won America's Trotting Classic in a driving downpour.

Ryder said he wondered how many times a horse has won the Hambletonian and didn't move to the top of the poll, but in the last 10 years, it's actually more the norm than the rarity.

In fact, the only two to do it were Atlanta (2018), who vaulted from fourth to first in the poll, as did Pinkman in 2015.

So far this year, Twin B Joe Fresh has never been lower than third in the rankings and has always garnered first-place votes.

Ryder said he liked Twin B Joe Fresh from the moment he saw her at the sale in Harrisburg.

“She was knock-dead gorgeous at the sale,” Ryder said. “She looked like a 3-year-old at the sale. But being a Roll With Joe I don't think she got much attention; filly, pacer, Roll With Joe. But I'd had the family before on the mother's side, which I think is top of the line. She goes back to Three Diamonds.

“And she was a fantastic individual, and I kind of had my heart set on her and when I bought her, I thought, ‘Oh, gee, \$65,000 for a Roll With Joe? I don't know what Dexter is going to think about this.’ And here we are.”

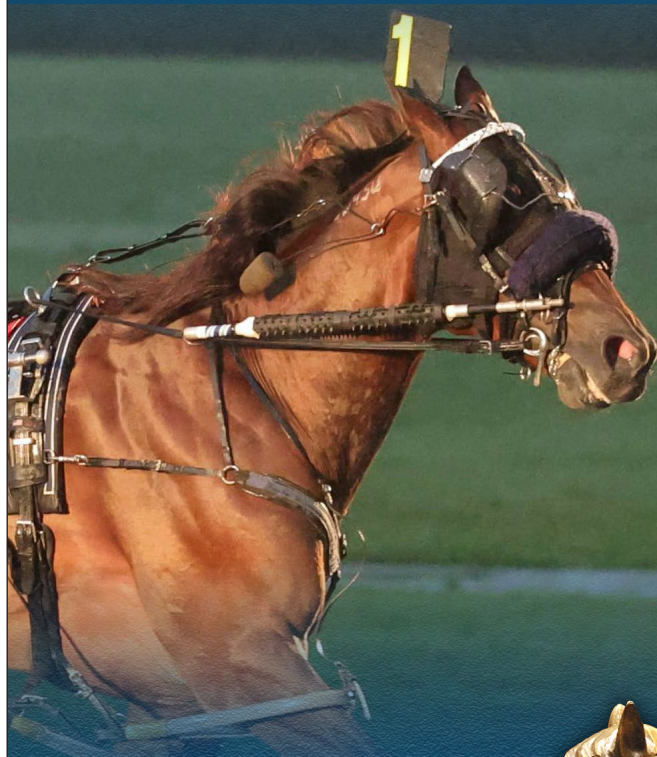
Dunn pointed out that Twin B Joe Fresh's half-brother, Twin B Fresh Bet, a son of Bettors Delight, sold at Harrisburg last year for \$500,000.

Dunn also gives Ryder all the accolades for picking out the now 4-year-old mare with a lifetime record of 34 25-6-1 and \$1.810,165 in the bank.

Just as Ryder was the first time he saw Twin B Joe Fresh, Dunn was also impressed.

“I don’t know if you’ve seen her up close but she was an absolute tank and she was like that as a baby,” Dunn said. “She was a big, strong girl with a big ass on her.

“It was like she was a 3-year-old when she was a baby. She was intelligent, and great to work with.”

The four-time Dan Patch Driver of the Year also said that it’s an advantage to drive a bright horse.

“I think you find that the good horses are usually pretty intelligent, and it’s 100 per cent easier for us to drive them because they almost know what you’re going to do before you do it,” Dunn said. “It’s a massive difference when you drive them, for sure.”

Whereas the transition from 3 to 4 is not always an easy one for some, Ryder said he felt that Twin B Joe Fresh would not have any problem with it. Although, he does see a difference in her this year.

“I just think she’s racing better,” Ryder said. “She’s always had a lot of speed and all that, but she’s just finishing off her miles better. At 2 and 3, things went wrong and she didn’t always win. Now, things might go wrong, but I think she’s still going to be tough.”

Ryder pointed out that Twin B Joe Fresh was the first 3-year-old pacer, regardless of sex, to win the FanDuel, but she was also the first sophomore filly regardless of gait to do it as well.

“I’ve said all along, I don’t know if I’ve said it to you, but she didn’t really go from 3 to 4, because the point I made is that she was an aged horse as a 3-year-old because she won the FanDuel against the aged mares,” he said. “That told me that her going from 3 to 4 was easier than the others because she was already at that level as a 3-year-old.”

For Dunn, winning with Twin B Joe Fresh capped off a Hambletonian Day that saw him register an impressive six winners, the most by any driver on a single card at The Meadowlands in 2024.

As for picking which win of the day was his favorite, Dunn was a little hesitant at first to say it was the one with Twin B Joe Fresh.

“I mean, it would probably be a bit of a tie with [Twin B Joe Fresh] and Jiggy Jog [S who won the Cashman],” Dunn said. “But I think when you own them, it’s even more of a special feeling when they’re winning races, big races, especially on Hambo Day. So, yeah, it probably was the best one of the day, for sure.”

The only blemish on a stellar stakes-laden resume this season for Twin B Joe Fresh, was her first start of the year when she faced older males in a winners of 5 but not more than 9 at Harrah’s Philadelphia, because they needed to get her raced.

At this moment, Ryder said he has no plans to face the boys again.

“People are suggesting it, but I’m not, no,” Ryder said. “If there’s a time and a place where we have nothing else to do and it looks like an okay shot, I don’t know, we’ll see. It’s not really in the wheelhouse at the moment.

“My objective after a few starts with her was to do everything I can to have a Horse of the Year. That’s why I skipped [the Clara Barton at] Plainridge. I just don’t want to ever have her where she might be a little tired or dull. I’ve just got to make sure she’s 100 [per cent] for every race. If it works, it works. We’ll see.”

ALL OVER ONTARIO

Gregg McNair is on track for an impressive sixth Johnston Cup

The race for the Johnston Cup, bestowed annually on the trainer atop the leaderboard at the end of the Ontario Sires Stakes season, is a lengthy, arduous endeavor.

Few know the feeling better than veteran trainer Gregg McNair, who currently leads his fellow conditioners with 123 Johnston points through the first three months of the 2024 OSS program.

As McNair prepares his charges for the home stretch of the OSS' 50th Anniversary campaign, the savvy horseman knows it's all about the numbers.

"Well, what helps you the most is building some strong numbers in the starts category," McNair said. "This year, we trained quite a few trotters, so that helped us on the trotting side. We normally don't have too many trotters. We didn't train nearly as many pacers as we usually do, so we'll be down on the entries on the pacing side."

The Guelph, ON-based horseman's trotter-heavy approach has paid dividends thus far.

Across a board-high 54 starts, McNair's pupils have compiled 10 wins (most), nine seconds (most), and one third.

The Johnston Cup, which was established in 1993 in memory of Bruce Johnston, publisher of *The Canadian Sportsman* magazine, follows a simple point system to determine the winner.

Four points are awarded for each win, three for each second, two for each third, and one for each start.

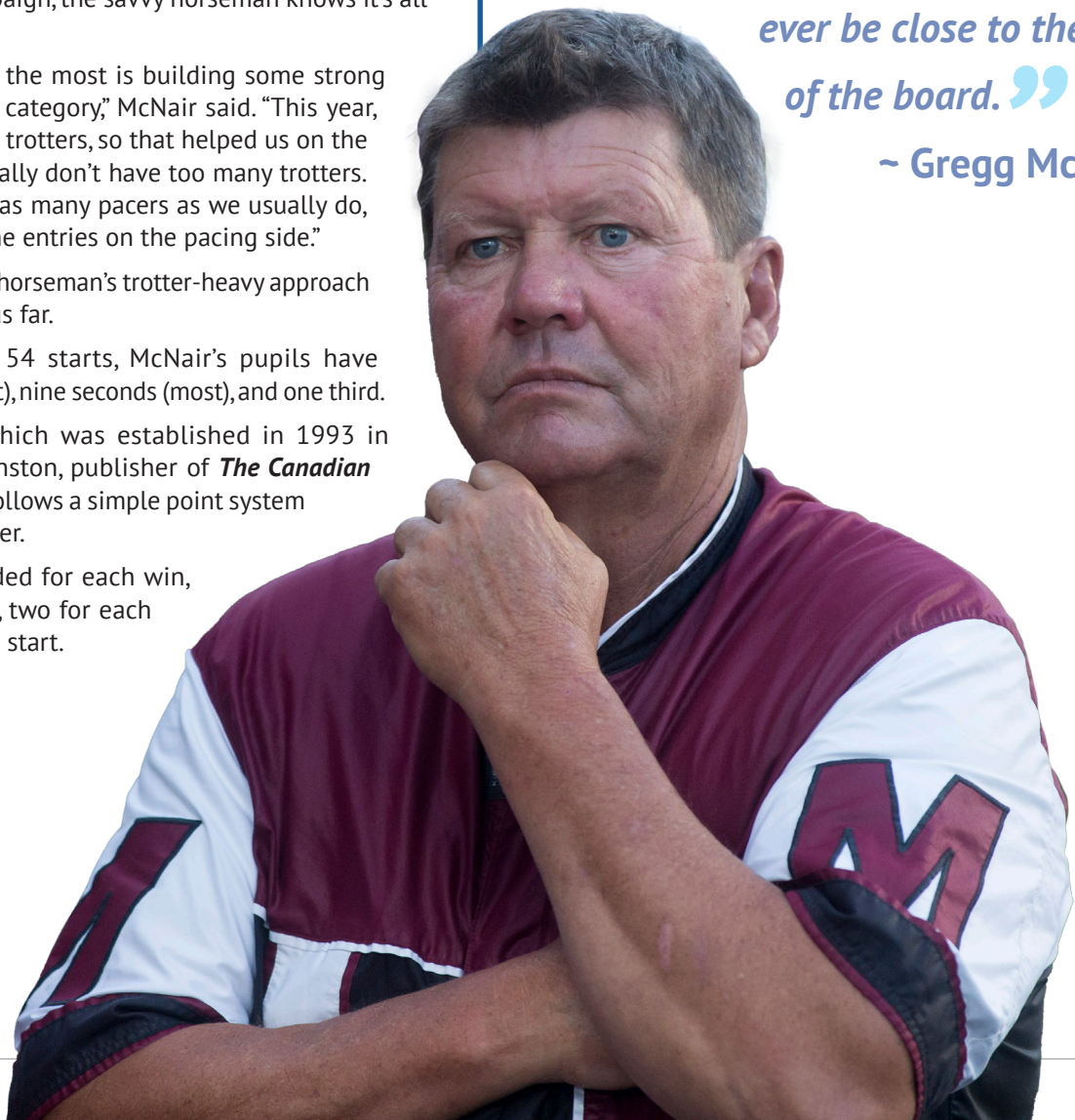

While McNair noted that it gets “a little tougher each year,” accumulating coveted Johnston points has become second nature, even if it didn’t seem so at first.

“Back years ago, when we first started, I never ever thought I’d ever be up near the top because, like I said, you have to race so many horses from the start right through to the end of the Grassroots finals and the Super Finals,” McNair said.

“We were only racing maybe half a dozen horses in the stakes then and it never ever crossed my mind that we’d ever be close to the top of the board.”

McNair’s big breakthrough came in 2012, when he hoisted the first of his five Johnston Cup titles (2012-14, 2019, 2021).

“It’s something to look back on and say that to win even one of them is pretty cool,” he said. “It’s quite an honor to win it. There are top trainers up here all the time.”

Among the elite trainers to share the oval with McNair was Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Famer, Bob McIntosh, who died on July 28 at the age of 71.

In the midst of yet another intense OSS competition, McNair stepped back to remember one of the game’s greats.

“I would think I raced against him more than anybody because I had a stable in Windsor for 10 or 11 years in the ’80s and ’90s and we’d race against him all the time at that track.”

McNair began his training career at the now defunct Windsor Raceway, where he joined G G Rita and driver Ken Hardy in the winner’s circle after his first career start on Jan. 2, 1992.

“Then we continued to compete after we moved up,” he said. “Bob was racing up here ahead of us, and we’d always race against him up here and in the Sires Stakes.

“We sure will miss hearing his name around the track.”

As McNair put it, even on the days you bested McIntosh, he would still be right on your heels.

“He was even racing the Grand Circuit back then,” McNair said. “I wasn’t, but Bob was the main opposition down there, too. If you were to ever win any dashes down there, he’d probably be the guy in second.”

McNair’s quest for yet another Johnston Cup crown continues over the weekend at Kawartha Downs (today, Aug. 9), where he will send out Beau Bear, a 2-year-old bay colt in search of career win number one.

Alongside the son of Bettors Delight, McNair’s roster of OSS competitors includes two exciting Green Manalishi offspring in Galen Erso and Sprite Seelster.

The former is another 2-year-old bay colt who has excelled in three OSS starts, going 2-1-0. Galen Erso last raced on Aug. 5 in a \$150,000 OSS Gold Mid-Season final at Mohawk, finishing second.

The latter, a competitor in the 2-year-old fillies division, is coming off a tough trip last time out (ninth) but showed plenty of promise with a strong second in a \$95,000 one-mile trot back on July 11 at Mohawk.

Despite the early success, McNair said he is still very much in the tinkering phase. But that’s normal at this point in the junction.

“I think I have a couple horses, maybe one or two, that could probably move up in class and probably one or two that could go down in class,” he said. “It’s still pretty early, especially for 2-year-olds. But things are rolling by quickly, so you have to move on the fly.”

As McNair continues to adjust his playbook, the accomplished conditioner remains upbeat ahead of what should be a dynamic finish to the 2024 OSS slate.

“We’re happy with how things are going,” McNair said, adding with a laugh, “If we’re complaining, then a lot of other people should be too. There’s still lots of horses that haven’t made any money but some of them have. It’s hard, some of them you think are a little better than what they turn out to be and it throws you off a bit. But some come the other way.

“There’s usually a reason for everything with the races. It just takes a while to find out what it is. That’s all.”

Some 32 years, 17,985 wins, and \$59.3 million in earnings later, McNair finds himself, once again, firmly in the mix for a sixth Johnston Cup trophy.

Sharp 'Buzzsaw' set for Dan Patch

What's in a name? Charlie Weaver always hopes it's a bit of good fortune.

Whenever Weaver shares ownership of a racehorse with his friend Russell Beeman, he includes his partner's name in the horse's name.

"He picks the horses and I pick the names," Weaver said. "I name them after Russ because Russ was always lucky. That's why I tag along with him. After we had success with the first horse we had together, I said I was hanging onto his belt and going for the ride."

The ride has been pretty good, particularly when it comes to 4-year-old male pacer Buzzsaw Russ. The son of Rockin Image—Up Front Cruiser has hit the board in 23 of 34 career races, winning 12 and earning \$539,754. He was an Indiana Sire Stakes champion at age 2.

Tonight (Aug. 9), Buzzsaw Russ will head to the \$300,000 Dan Patch Stakes for older male pacers at Harrah's Hoosier Park as the 5-2 morning-line favorite. He will start from post 3 in a field of 10 with John DeLong driving for trainer Missy Essig.

Buzzsaw Russ has won three of his past four races, including a 1:48.3 score in his most recent on July 26 in the open at Hoosier Park. He stopped the clock in 1:48.4 in his two victories prior to that.

"When he's on his game, he's very tough," said Beeman, who is in the timber industry. "When you take him to race, he knows what he's fixin' to do. When he comes off a helmet, he's quick. He can come home in 25 seconds if he gets a trip at all.

"He's sharp right now, and hopefully he's sharp [tonight]."

Beeman counts millionaire pacer Little Rocket Man, a three-time participant in the Dan Patch with a best finish of fourth twice, among his top horses. Weaver said Buzzsaw Russ is the best horse he's ever owned.

"I've had some nice ones, but nothing like him," Weaver said. "He's a dream horse. He's fast, he's easy to work around, and he always tries. He's got so much speed on the end of the mile and John DeLong does a good job driving him and knows him well. Missy and her husband, Joe, do a great job with the horses. They're the reason for his success.

"When it's time to race, [Buzzsaw Russ] knows what day it is, and he wants to win."

Tonight's Dan Patch Stakes field includes Rocknroll Runa A, who won last week's Sam McKee Memorial at odds of 68-1 at The Meadowlands. He will start from post 6 with Mark MacDonald driving for trainer Larry Stalbaum and is the 7-2 second choice on the morning line. Next, at 4-1, is Coach Stefanos, who won last week's open at Hoosier Park. He will leave from post 7 with Trace Tetrick in the sulky for Erv Miller.

"Everyone in the field is wanting to win that race, and we'd like to win it," Weaver said. "But the world doesn't come to an end if you don't. It's horseracing."



The Dan Patch Stakes card will air live on Fox Sports 2 from 8-11 p.m. (EDT) with Gabe Prewitt and Jessica Otten on site to offer analysis. Racing begins at 6:15 p.m. with the 31st edition of the Dan Patch slated for 10:38 p.m. as race 13.

Its A Love Thing notches fourth straight at The Red Mile

On Tuesday (Aug. 6) **Its A Love Thing** made her first visit to the Bluegrass State a victorious one to stake her claim as a top contender in her division with a 1:49.4 triumph in the first \$80,000 leg of the Kentucky Sire Stakes Championship Series for 3-year-old filly pacers. It was her fourth consecutive pari-mutuel win.

Leaving from post position 5 in the field of six, the David Menary-trainee allowed Direction (Todd McCarthy) to establish the first split of the mile of 28 seconds while she and pilot James MacDonald commenced their journey in third. Bath Bomb (Yannick Gingras) sat in second.

It did not take long, however, for Its A Love Thing to assert her power as the daughter of Bettors Delight—Love For Sail briskly took control before the half-mile marker in :55.3. From there on her rivals gave chase but to no avail as the filly swept by the quarter-pole in 1:23 and paced a :26.4 final quarter-mile to win by three-quarters-of-a-length to grace the winner's circle for the very first time in Lexington.

Direction and Bath Bomb raced well in the drive for the wire to place second and third with :26.4 and :26.3 last panels.

Its A Love Thing paid \$2.24 as the heavy favorite she deserved to be. The filly was fourth in the \$700,000 Breeders Crown final as a freshman and captured the \$399,600 She's A Great Lady final as one of her six wins in 12 trips to the post in 2023.

This year Its A Love Thing annexed the \$310,250 Fan Hanover final at Woodbine Mohawk Park and the \$100,000 John Steele Memorial at The Meadowlands on Hambletonian Day.

Owned by Erik Good, Thomas Biederman, Joshua Green and Rich Lombardo Racing, Its A Love Thing is the first foal out of the Captaintreacherous mare Love For Sail. Her granddam is the Western Ideal mare West Side Glory, who also foaled dual Dan Patch Award winner

and world champion See You At Peelers (Bettors Delight, \$1.57 million) and Live Entertainment (Real Artist, \$230,502).

Its A Love Thing was bred by Marvin Katz, Lynn Katz and Al Libfield and went through the ring at the 2022 Standardbred Horse Sale for \$65,000 to her current owners.

The filly has now banked \$840,001 from a career record of 20 12-4-1.

CAPYTREACH UPSETS IN COMMONWEALTH SERIES LEG

Andy Miller and **Capytreach** denied Real Deal Lindy (Gingras) and favored Defining Moment (David Miller) a victory by stopping the clock in 1:50.1, a new lifetime best, at odds of 18-1 in the first \$30,000 leg of the Kentucky Commonwealth Series for sophomore filly pacers.

The daughter of Captaintreacherous—Southwind Thundra collected her second victory from nine starts this season and now has earned \$136,145 in purse money for her career. Her lifetime resume stands at 18 3-4-4.

Capytreach has been knocking on the door with three second place finishes in her last four miles.

Trained by Tony Dinges, Capytreach is owned by Erik Good, West Wins Stable and Mark Dumain. The filly's dam is a full sister to dual Dan Patch Award winner and world champion Southwind Tempo (\$2.39 million).

Capytreach is the first foal from Southwind Thundra and fetched \$55,000 at the 2022 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale.

The filly paid a healthy \$38.12 to her supporters.

Hall trainees double in Maryland Race Fund splits

Ocean Downs' leading trainer, Michael Hall, swept both \$26,075 divisions of the Maryland Standardbred Race Fund (MSRF) stakes for 2-year-old pacing fillies on Wednesday (Aug. 7), sending both **Ragtime Red** and **Little Instigator** to open-length wins over the seaside half-mile oval.

Ragtime Red drilled a 1:55.4 maiden-breaking mile in the second division to take top honors. In line to Trae Porter, the Getitoffyourchest—Red High Heels filly left from post 2 and seated Preclude (driven by Jonathan Roberts) in the pocket through a :29 first quarter. After rating a :59.1 half, Ragtime Red edged clear of Preclude up the backstretch, opening a 3½-length lead to three-quarters in 1:27.3 before sprinting home in :28.1 to evade a late charge from 3-5 favorite Lyons Benz (Victor Kirby) by 2½ lengths. Bella Artiste (Jim Morand) rallied to collar Preclude for third, another 14½ lengths behind.

Ragtime Red, who paid \$4.80 to win as the 7-5 second choice, competes as a homebred for David Banks.

The first division saw William and Sarah MacMillan's Little Instigator (\$2.10) get back into the win column by way of a pillar-to-post 1:57.2 score, good for her third career win in five starts. Jonathan Roberts put the Heston Blue Chip—Last Time To Play filly in play from post 4, and she cleared Baby Doll Jordyn (William Carter) before the :28.4 first quarter. After rating middle splits of :59.1 and 1:28.1, Little Instigator pulled away to defeat Baby Doll Jordyn by 3¼ lengths, with Pawny (Corey Braden) finishing a neck farther back in third.

K J The Thirteenth (\$2.80) took top honors among 2-year-old trotting fillies with a 2:01.4 maiden-breaking win in her \$23,725 MSRF split. Tony Morgan sat last in a four-horse field with the Il Mago—My Kid Sister filly before swinging three-wide up the backstretch and vaulting four lengths clear of Take It Easy. John Wagner trains K J The Thirteenth for Kelsey Wagner and co-breeder Scott Woogen.

The other \$23,725 MSRF split for rookie trotting fillies saw **Casino Magic** (\$11.60) and driver Roger Plante, Jr. gap 1-9 leader Watch Me Goo This (Johnathan Ahle) by 15 lengths at the 1:31 three-quarters but inherit the lead as the tempo-setting favorite broke stride turning for home. Casino Magic, a daughter of Il Mago—Emily's Ego, got to the line a neck in front of the recovering Watch Me

Goo This in 2:03.1, with Y'all Know Me third, beaten only a length. Steve LeBlanc trains two-time winner Casino Magic for his LeBlanc Racing Inc., William Lutz, Jr., Count De Money Stable and Douglas Johnson.

Leading drivers Ahle and Porter steered three winners apiece on the 11-race card; Morgan fashioned a double.

UNDEFEATED PRIMO MASCHIO ROMPS IN MSRF

After sweeping the Bucky Gray, Jr. Memorial Series, **Primo Maschio** kept his undefeated career record intact with a devastating 13¾-length score in his \$27,275 Maryland Standardbred Race Fund (MSRF) event for 2-year-old male pacers on Sunday (Aug. 4) at Ocean Downs.

Trae Porter, who used front-end and pocket tactics with Primo Maschio in his three previous wins, floated the Badlands Hanover—Primadonna gelding into third and rated well off a :55.3 first-half duel between Brooksforreal and Charge Me Up before making his move. Primo Maschio took aim with three-eighths to go and pushed clear of Brooksforreal nearing the 1:25.1 three-quarters before powering to a career-best 1:54.3 win. Brooksforreal (driven by Corey Braden) held second over Charge Me Up (Jonathan Roberts).

Kevin Lare trains Primo Maschio, who paid \$2.60 to win, for owner Forrest Bartlett.

Flight In Motion and trainer/driver Eddie Dennis won the other \$27,275 MSRF split for rookie male pacers, sweeping three-wide up the backstretch and defeating pacesetter Happy Jim by 4½ lengths in 1:57.3. The Betting Line—Tidewaterdragonfly gelding, who has now won two of four races for Mulligan Stables and Jason L. Johnson Inc., paid \$4.60 to win.

In the lone \$45,600 MSRF dash for 2-year-old male trotters, the debuting **Yall Keep Dreaming** swept from last to first to defeat Prince Of Royals by 2½ lengths in 2:01. Johnathan Ahle drove the Yall Beneath Me—Upside Blue Chip colt, who paid \$3 to win, for owner/trainer Richard Hans.

Eric Davis led all drivers with three wins on the 12-race program.

by two lengths in a :27.2 closer to win in 1:56.4.

There were also three \$20,000 Excelsior stakes on the card.

The second went to **Digging For Gold** (Huntsville–Gold Orchid N) in 1:56.3, driven by Tyler Buter for trainer George Ducharme who co-owns with Jim Winske and Dr. Megan Moschgat. Bamq LLC bred the winner.

The third was won by **Invictus** (Huntsville–Dark Force) in 1:56.4, driven by Jim Morrill, Jr. for trainer Roland Mallar and owner Jeffrey Nanna. James Crawford IV bred the winner.

Monalishi, You Got It Kemp claim Gold finals

A pair of \$150,000 Ontario Sires Stakes Gold Mid-Season finals for rookie trotters highlighted the Monday (Aug. 5) card at Mohawk, seeing **Monalishi** deliver as the favorite in the trotting filly division while **You Got It Kemp** pulled the mild 7-1 upset in the trotting colts.

With regular pilot Jody Jamieson aboard, Monalishi left from post 2 in the full field of 10 as the 7-5 bettor's choice. Monalishi got away mid-pack early, settling in fifth on the opening turn while Medley Seelster (driven by Bob McClure) crossed over from post 10 to lead to the quarter in :27.2. The lead changed hands multiple times on the backstretch, with Trevor Henry putting 65-1 shot The Green Book on top from third before being covered up by Foxy Ameer (Paul MacDonell) at the half in :57. Jamieson gave Monalishi her cue on the final turn, brushing first-up to grab a short lead on the outside of Foxy Ameer at three-quarters in 1:25.3 as the lead duo separated from the field.

Monalishi carried the momentum off the turn to trot clear to a three-length lead midway down the lane with Foxy Ameer trying to counter from second. From there, Monalishi coasted home a winner to cross the line 1¼ lengths clear of Foxy Ameer in a career best 1:54.2. Medley Seelster held for third to round out the trifecta.

"She's very willing, she wants to do it," said driver Jody Jamieson, "I got her scored down a little bit and she was just waiting for me to call on her and I did. I had to call on her pretty good. I raced her tough tonight and she responded, I was pretty proud of her."

After a miscue in her career debut in the Tompkins-Geers, the Blake Macintosh trainee has won each of her following three starts all in Ontario Sires Stakes Gold competition. The daughter of Green Manalishi S—Pretty Phylly G was bred by Shmuel Farhi and has now banked \$170,000 for owners Blake Macintosh and Tim Klemencic.

You Got It Kemp teamed up with driver Sylvain Filion to score from off cover to upset in the freshman male final. Much like the trotting fillies, Filion landed the eventual winner in fifth early from post 4 while Lookatmegoamigo (Louis-Philippe Roy) made quick work of post 10 to reach the quarter first in :28.1. Chicago Hall (James MacDonald) passed on the pocket trip to take command on the backstretch before Doug McNair moved the 3-5 favorite, Galen Erso, to the lead before reaching the half in :58.1. Filion flushed the cover of Rising Interest (Tyler Borth) who led the charge first-over into third on the final turn while Galen Erso led to three-quarters in 1:27.1.

Filion tipped You Got It Kemp off of cover at the top of the lane with sights set on Galen Erso who was now under pressure from Chicago Hall who popped the pocket once more. You Got It Kemp got in gear in deep stretch with a :27.2 final quarter to nail Galen Erso by a half-length on the wire in 1:55.1. Chicago Hall finished third.

"When I tipped him off cover, he went forward, but I didn't know if I had enough track left to get there," said Filion. "Obviously he did, so I was really pleased with

him. I think he raced super tonight. Even last week, the way he did it, we got out real late and he sprinted home like a machine. I was pretty pleased with him and pretty confident in tonight too.”

A winner now in two of three in his young career, You Got It Kemp is trained by Daniel Lagace. A gelded son of Muscle Mass—Speed Titan, You Got It Kemp was bred by Kemppi Stables Oy and Suojalampi Stable. Suojalampi Stable co-owns the earner of \$110,667 along with Brady, Brooke and Daniel Lagace.

The 10-race card kicked off with **Shutter Green** (Todd Ratchford) securing a front-end 1:57.2 victory in the \$40,000 OSS Gold Mid-Season consolation for trainer Mark Etsell. The victory was the first in three starts for the son of Green Manalishi S—Perfect Summer K who is owned by Etsell along with Grant Turner, Peter Porter and Graham Hopkins.

RICH GIRL ROLLS IN GRASSROOTS

Rich Girl banked herself the lion’s share of the \$20,000 purse in one of four divisions of the Ontario Sires Stakes Grassroots Series at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Tuesday (Aug. 6) without having to extend any credit of her own.

The four divisions served as the third leg of the OSS Grassroots Series for freshman trotting fillies and the young ladies will meet again for the fourth leg on Sept. 7 at Hiawatha Horse Park.

Setting the swiftest time of the day, Bob McClure and the Wheeling N Dealin—You Cant Afford Me filly charged from their post 8 position and secured the lead. Without looking back and brushing off all of her foes, Rich Girl controlled the timer in :29, :59.3, and 1:28.4 before going on to win by 1¼ lengths in 1:57.4. Marie H (Trevor Henry) finished second with D A Dream Girl (Travis Cullen) third.

Trainer John Pentland co-owns the winner with Alan Bodin. Recording her first win, Rich Girl moved her lifetime tally to 1-2-1 in five starts. Backed as the bettors’ choice, the freshman filly returned \$3.60 to win.

The three other divisions of OSS Grassroots action were each won by daughters of Green Manalishi S.

Opening the card and the stakes action, **Wings Of Green** (\$50.20) and Trevor Henry went to the gate as the second longest shot on the board at 24-1 odds. Yet, the Green Manalishi S—Sensual Hall filly braved the mile from post 7 to victory by three-quarters of a length in 1:58.4 for trainer Paul Davis, who co-owns Wings Of Green with Nicole Davies.

Bright Green (\$3.70) and Louis-Philippe Roy followed in the next division, passing the pacesetter at the wire to win by just a neck in 1:59.2. Eric Nadeau trains the Green Manalishi S—Shine Bright filly for Ecurie Csl and Louis-Philippe Roy Racing.

Travis Cullen and **Ibelieveinangels** (\$10.50) completed the OSS Grassroots action with a third-over bid to victory by 2¾ lengths in 1:58.1. The Green Manalishi S—Angel Eyes Hanover filly is owned by W J Donovan and trained by Meg Crone.

Field established for 31st Dan Patch Stakes at Harrah's Hoosier Park

Ten of the sports top older pacers are set to square off tonight (Aug. 9) at Harrah's Hoosier Park for the 31st edition of the Dan Patch Stakes presented by Indiana Standardbred Breed Development. Trainer Missy Essig's Buzzsaw Russ has been established as the 5-2 morning-line favorite. The locally owned pacer looks to follow in the footsteps of 2023 champion, Ponda Warrior, as just the third Indiana bred to win the Dan Patch.

Slated to leave from post 3 with regular pilot John De Long aboard, Buzzsaw Russ enters tonight's race a winner of three in his last four, including a 1:48.3 career best effort against open company at Harrah's Hoosier Park in his last outing on July 26. In all, the gelded son of Rockin Image—Up Front Cruiser has won half of his eight starts in his 4-year-old campaign. Owned by Russ Beeman and Charles Weaver, Buzzsaw Russ sports a career bankroll of \$539,754. Both Essig and De Long are in search of their first victories in the Dan Patch, having teamed with Little Rocket Man in 2021 and 2022 with finishes of fourth and fifth respectively.

With combined career purse earnings of over \$7.2 million, the 2024 edition features a host of fresh faces with seven 4-year-olds in the field. The only horse in the field with any prior Dan Patch experience is Charlie May, who will leave from the same post position he finished third from in the 2023 edition, post 10. Charlie May leads the field in career earnings; however, the double-millionaire enters the Dan Patch in search of his first victory in 2024 and has been established at 12-1 on the morning line.

Coming in off of a 68-1 upset in the \$220,000 Sam McKee on Hambletonian Day, Rocknroll Runa A has been designated much shorter odds on the Dan Patch morning, receiving respect as the 7-2 second-choice for trainer Larry Stalbaum. Mark MacDonald, who guided the 7-year-old son of Rock N Roll Heaven—She's A Runa to the career best 1:47.3 upset score, is listed to drive once again. With over a quarter-million dollars made this year, the seven-time winner in 2024 will leave from post 6.

Right next door in post 7, Harrah's Hoosier Park's all-time leading driver Trace Tetrick looks for his first Dan Patch victory with the Indiana bred Coach Stefanos. The Erv Miller trainee is listed as the 4-1 third-choice on the morning line, coming off of a 1:50.2

victory against open company at Hoosier Park. A winner of two of nine on the year including a 1:47.3 career best effort in a leg of the Graduate at The Meadowlands, a win in the Dan Patch would cement millionaire status for the career earner of \$873,406.

The evening will be the first of two Harrah's Hoosier Park cards aired on Fox Sports this season, with the Caesars Trotting Classic on Friday (Sept. 20) slated to air nationally as well.

Those on track will be able to enjoy a live performance by Cook & Belle in The Hop from 7-10 p.m. to go along with outdoor activities, food trucks, Vanilla Bean creamery, face painting and much more. First post tonight is slated for 6:15 p.m.

The Dan Patch race has become a tradition that is close to the hearts of Hoosiers. The Dan Patch not only highlights some of the best athletes in the sport of harness racing but is deeply rooted throughout Indiana history. The Dan Patch race was established at Harrah's Hoosier Park in 1994 with Ready To Rumble and driver Trevor Ritchie winning the inaugural edition 31 years ago. The list of all-star horses that have made their way to Harrah's Hoosier Park over the years includes Jenna's Beach Boy, Sweet Lou and world record holder, Bulldog Hanover.

It's Academic looks to defend crown in Aldrich

\$2.4 million earner It's Academic returns to his Ohio roots on Saturday (Aug. 10) and looks to defend his title in the \$100,000 Tom Aldrich President's Trot at MGM Northfield Park.

It's Academic, installed as the 3-5 morning-line favorite by director of racing Dave Bianconi, has been lightly raced this season.

Dan Patch award-winning older male in 2023, It's Academic kicked off his season in the \$131,250 Crawford Farms trot at The Meadowlands, after qualifying several times in preparation for the races. He rallied from well off the pace to finish a game fourth in that effort.

He then shipped to Plainridge Park, where he put together an impressive performance, winning easily in 1:51.2 in the \$250,000 Spirit of Massachusetts. He then shipped back to The Meadowlands to race in the \$282,000 John Cashman Memorial, and set stiff fractions before tiring and finishing eighth.

"He got a tough trip last week, I expect him to be better in the Aldrich," said trainer Ron Burke.

Owned by Bradley Grant of Milton, ON, he has 31 victories, with \$2,444,333 in career earnings, more than anyone he will face on Saturday.

He will battle some talented foes including Rose Run Yolanda, Herecomescharlie B, Caviar Gold, Shine All The Way, Refined, Black Magic, Don't Take My Keys, and Guido Di.

An Ohio Sires Stakes star at 2 and 3, Racing Rampage will try to continue his winning ways in Saturday's \$100,000 Myron Charna President's Pace.

Trained by Travis Alexander, for Darren Dowler, and Lawrence Bettler, the son of Racing Hill enters Saturday on a two-race win streak, having won five of eight starts in 2024.

Wish You Well, a runner-up in the Delvin Miller Adios at The Meadows, has been installed as the 5-2 favorite and leads a competitive field in Saturday's (Aug. 10) \$300,000 Carl Milstein Memorial at MGM Northfield Park.

The Carl Milstein Memorial an invitational for 3-year-old pacers is always one of the staples on the stakes calendar each year.

"The year's Milstein is a wide-open race, with horses from all over North America," said director of racing Dave Bianconi. "The \$300,000 event, in addition to the power-packed undercard will make for a great night of racing."

After a slow start to his sophomore campaign, Wish You Well entered the \$350,000 Adios off a victory at Harrah's Philadelphia, and a dominant 1:49.1 score in the \$25,000 elimination.

In the final, the son of Bettor's Wish had a big late kick, but ran out of racetrack, missing by a neck to Captain Albano in 1:49.2. Wish You Well is owned by Kovach Stables, LLC and is trained by Nifty Norman.

"He has had an easy week at The Meadows, we are thrilled with the post draw," said Norman. "He trains on a half, and raced in the Messenger earlier this year, he doesn't mind it at all."

Lightly raced at 2, Indiana standout Sabonis, will take on Grand Circuit company for the first time in Saturday's Carl Milstein Memorial. The 3-year-old son by Tellitlikeitis enters on a seven-race win streak, and sports 10 victories in 11 starts this year for owner Pat Miller and trainer Aaron Stutzman.

"He matured a lot from his 2- to 3-year-old season, last year wasn't his year, he was a little immature," said Stutzman. "He has surprised all of us with how good he has been this year. The races he has been in at Hoosier have been tough."

The talented colt started the year with a powerful 5½-length victory in a non-winners of two final at Harrah's Hoosier Park before tasting defeat for the first time. He returned to win another late closer, and no one has been close to him in Indiana Sire Stakes company. It will be the first time Sabonis will race away from Harrah's Hoosier Park, something his connections aren't worried about. "I [Stutzman] guess we will find out how good he will be on a half. He trains on a half and I don't expect any surprises."

Also competing in Saturday's Grand Circuit event is Stable.ca standout Timeisonmyside, Ohio-sired Rose Run Zane, Ohio State Fair runner-up Janelle Granny, Ontario Sires Stakes standout Storm Shadow, MGM Messenger winner Sweet Beach Life, Ohio-sired Paris's Dragon, and Indiana Sired Noblesville.

Historically hosted in October, the Courageous Lady Stakes will move to the undercard of the Carl Milstein Memorial in 2024, with the addition of Ohio Super Night in October. The 2023 edition featured the Home of the Flying Turns first dead heat in a Grand Circuit Event, with Ucandoit Blue Chip and Zanatta hitting the wire together.

Odds On Platinum will ship-in from Canada on Saturday for trainer Dr. Ian Moore, looking to continue her winning ways. A runner-up in the \$219,000 Ontario Super Final as a 2-year-old, the daughter of Bettors Delight, has shown a lot of ability against Grand Circuit company. Her connections are pleased with the draw and look forward to seeing her compete against top talent again.

"She has really turned into a good filly, the draw hasn't been kind to her lately, we are thankful she can leave the gate well," said Moore. "I picked her out as a yearling, our entire team has enjoyed working with her."

Trainer Linda Toscano will try to repeat in the Courageous Lady with the daughter of Stay Hungry, Sarasota Hanover. She won a division of the Bluegrass in Lexington as a 2-year-old and won a division of the Kindergarten at The Meadowlands, before finishing a strong fourth in the \$376,000 Three Diamonds final at The Meadowlands.

She is also the fastest sophomore filly pacer in North America in 2024, with a dazzling 1:48.1 victory in May at The Meadowlands.

The talented filly looks to return to winning ways on Saturday against Fearless Ginger, Genetic Edge, Gone Coastal, Wasted On You, Soft Shot, Seaside Diva, and Flyin Bullets.

Saturday's Carl Milstein Memorial program will get underway at 6 p.m. and feature a \$25,000 guaranteed \$1 Pick-4 beginning in race 8, with a \$10,000 guaranteed \$1 Pick-4 beginning in race 11, and a \$10,000 guaranteed 20-cent Super Hi-5 in race 13.
