Driver Scott Zeron stole the show on Hambletonian Day and didn't need a horse to do it.

Unable to compete following an accident on July 26 at Pocono Downs, Zeron spent some of his day in front of the camera, co-hosting The Meadowlands' simulcast show for about two hours with Dave Little.

"He brought insights that we don't normally have," said Little. "Dave Brower and I have been at this a long time and we have a lot of chemistry, but it's always nice every once in a while, to mix it up. It's the first time since I've been there that I've co-hosted with a horseman. I think it really creates a treat for the fans because Scott is so recognizable and he's so eloquent about everything harness racing. It just worked out much better than I anticipated.

Little invited Zeron to spend time in the Hambletonian Day co-host’s chair due to his regular partner, Brower, being committed to the CBS Sports Network broadcast.

Zeron has long said that he thought utilizing a horseman in such a capacity would only aid the existing product.

“Everybody loves Tony Romo and people are already trying to poach Tom Brady and he’s still playing,” said Zeron. “I guess it offers that different perspective than the two Daves. I had always preached that we should try and get somebody like a Mike Lachance, so I was definitely going to practice what I preached.”

Little was concerned about how Zeron would cope with the oppressive heat, the wobbly steps leading up to the outdoor set and a lot of wires that Little likened to a game of Twister, since

Zeron, who is recovering from a fractured pelvis, dislocated shoulder and tiny wrist fracture, could barely walk a week prior to the Hambletonian and was brought to the set by his parents in a wheelchair.

“I would have been more than happy to carry Scott Zeron up

the steps if that was the difference between him coming on set or not,” said Little with a laugh. “He never once complained about the heat and, in fact, his mom and dad were out there, too. I’ve known his dad, Rick, for over 30 years, so it was nice to hang out with him, too. And Scott’s mom, Joyce, kept asking us if we needed a bottle of water. Considering I drank about a dozen bottles that day, I was sure glad she was there to help.

“At one point, being a real mom, Joyce saw that Scott had an aptitude for being an on-camera personality and she said to me ‘This is safer.’ But then I whispered back to her, ‘Yeah, but it doesn’t pay quite as much.’ And we both got a good laugh over that.”

Ironically, before Zeron started driving, this is what his mom wanted him to do. And for his part, Zeron was not nervous about doing the show. Since he’s done a lot of interviews, he just looked at this as being simply a longer version.

“This was easy because I didn’t have to carry a conversation,” said Zeron. “Dave was just throwing the ball up in the air and I was just slam-dunking it. We were just Pippen and Jordan.

“I didn’t know it was going to be the spectacle that it was. Obviously, Dave gave me the best four races on the whole card. It’s super easy talking about races when there’s 10 competitive horses in it. I’m happy it was just the four races and not 16. I don’t know if I could have handled 16. But it was fun.”

Little believed that Zeron would be good in the role, but admits you never quite know how someone will do until they’re live on camera.

“I’ve interviewed Scott quite a few times and we have a good relationship,” said Little. “I don’t know that I can say that I knew we’d have chemistry, but I knew that there was a very good chance of it.

“He did confide in me at one point during the course of the day ‘You know, Dave, it’s an awful lot of fun to be here but I hope I don’t have to do it again real soon.’ And I didn’t blame him one bit.”

Zeron hopes to be back in the bike in four to six weeks, but for now, he’s working every day to keep his recovery on the right track and spending a lot of time answering complimentary texts and posts.

“It was extremely well received and I didn’t really see that coming,” said Zeron. “I’m happy I didn’t stay home. I didn’t realize how great it was going to be to do that. I might be an introverted person by nature, but if you talk to me about something I’m passionate about, I become pretty extroverted. So, it was easy.

“People’s second sentence after they said that was a great show, was you may have a backup after you retire. I think I got more messages from people, whether it be texts or social media, saying how great the show was and how nice it was to hear that perspective, than I got texts congratulating me on winning the Hambletonian.”

Johnathan Ahle: Every time I get on the track it feels like a highlight

It's an answer that perfectly captures Johnathan Ahle's passion for horse racing.

There is a pause, albeit slight, when the 25-year-old standardbred driver and trainer is asked to pick out a special moment in his career to date.

"Big highlights... I don't think there have been that many so far," said Ahle. "For me, I would say, getting my first training win at Freehold with my horse Lynbar Rose. That was pretty cool. I got my first driving win at Freehold as well, with Bungalow Bill N. Other than that, it's all a highlight. Every time I get on the track it feels like a highlight."

Seven years ago, a life in racing wasn't on the radar for Ahle.

In fact, he didn't know much about the sport or the horses. One conversation changed all of that.

"I worked in a restaurant, doing all kinds of different jobs – waiter, server, working behind the counter – but that wasn't a forever thing," said Ahle. "I met [trainer] Shaun Vallee's daughter, Sarah, and that's how it all started. I think the family was going away on vacation and they needed help around the barn. So, I went over there and started cleaning out stalls, whatever they needed."

The daily menu of tasks was completely different than what he was used to, but there was something about it that resonated with Ahle.

"I didn't start in the business until I was around 17, when I started working for Shaun. I didn't know a thing about horses at the time. I started out doing buckets and stalls, and it just intrigued me, being around the horses and seeing them train. Little by little, I started jogging and training. That all led me to where I am now."

In 2019, Ahle launched his driving and training careers, going winless in a modest number of starts. One year later, he posted his first victory as a conditioner. His first win in the race bike came in 2021.

This year, the New Jersey native has revved up things in the sulky, having already reached numerous career-best numbers, including starts, wins and purse earnings.

He's also fared well on the training side, having surpassed previous-high totals in top-three finishes and purse earnings.

"Pretty soon after I started working for him, I was intrigued with the whole business, racing and training and taking care of the horses. I started out helping around the barn, doing the feed tubs and stalls and stuff like that, and one thing led to the next. I started jogging, then that led to training, and eventually everything played out to where I am now."

There have been challenges along the journey, perhaps most notably, in the desire to establish himself as a regular driver.

Striving to achieve that goal is a daily focal point.

“I’m really trying to push the driving aspect of my career because I enjoy it so much. So far, it’s the favorite part of the business. It’s difficult to pick up drives because there is a lot of competition obviously. You just hope you can drive well and keep the horse for its next start. I would say that’s the biggest hurdle for me now.”

Paying attention to details, big and small, isn’t an issue for Ahle.

“I think I’ve picked up enough knowledge that could fit into three brains over the past seven years I’ve been doing this,” he said with a laugh. “The biggest thing I’ve learned is to listen to what the horses are saying to you. They don’t speak our language, but they speak in their own way. I just listen to what they are telling me.”

Those interactions have no doubt helped Ahle, especially in more recent times.

Whether it’s time spent with the horses or helpful advice he gets from Vallee, Ahle is grateful to expand his knowledge of the sport.

“When it comes to best skill as a driver, I guess I’d say staying in the seat,” he quipped. “Obviously, I’m kidding. I don’t think I have one skill that really stands out. I’m still learning every day. I’m always trying to improve so that I do have a best skill.”

Ahle’s racing colors are a tip of the cap to Vallee.

“I went with red and black – I’m not sure where I really came up with the design – because those are Shaun’s colors. I owe everything I know to him and his wife Anita. I just thought it would be cool to keep his colors and change the design around a little bit.”

He’s also developed an appreciation for making the trek to the winner’s circle.

Ahle is hopeful there are more win photos, especially as a driver, out there to add to his collection.

“At one point, thought of being a driver seemed so far-fetched. Then, I started doing the amateurs and realized how much I liked it, and I had some success. I’ve been driving in some of the overnights at Chester, so I think I’ll move on from the amateur ranks. I’m really trying to drive as much as I can and drive well, so that I can keep doing it. That’s my long-term goal, to keep driving, keep learning, and keep getting better at it so that I can make a career out of it.”

And when he’s not focused on elevating his skillset, don’t expect to find Ahle with his feet up on the couch.

The indoor life is not for him.

“I like to surf. I don’t do many team sports. It’s all about being outdoors. I love that, whatever it may be. I could be on a beach or a trail. Outdoors is where I like to be.”

So too is working around the horses.

Ahle’s connection with the pacers and trotters continues to grow stronger.

With his amateur driving career coming to a close, he hopes the best is yet to come.

“The sport and the horses, it just draws you in. It’s almost impossible to let go. When I first started, there wasn’t one specific horse that I developed a bond with. They were all very special, but it’s not like the bonds I’ve created now. Every horse is different and you can’t treat them all the same. That would never work. Every horse has their own little quirks, and you find out what they like, what they don’t like, and what they can and can’t do.”

Tellmeaboutit looks to beat the odds again

Alvin Miller knows what it's like to bring a longshot to the Dan Patch Stakes. He also knows that anything is possible, even for a longshot.

Last year, Miller's Tellmeaboutit was 68-1 from post nine in the annual event for older male pacers at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino but came charging from the back of the pack in :25.2 over the final quarter-mile to finish second by a neck to Catch The Fire.

Tonight (Aug. 12), Tellmeaboutit again will be a longshot when he meets nine foes in this year's \$315,000 Dan Patch Stakes. The event features headliner Bulldog Hanover, who in his most recent start on July 16 in the William R. Haughton Memorial at The Meadowlands, won in a history-making 1:45.4 and brings a six-race victory streak to Hoosier Park. The 4-year-old stallion is the 3-5 morning-line favorite.

The field also includes Rockyroad Hanover, who last month won a division of the Roll With Joe Stakes in 1:46.2 and subsequently finished second twice behind Bulldog Hanover, including in the Haughton. Last week, the 4-year-old stallion was second to Catch The Fire, who is sitting out the Dan Patch, in the Sam McKee Memorial.

Rockyroad Hanover is 9-2. The only other horse with morning-line odds less than 15-1 is Abuckabett Hanover, who is 6-1.

Tellmeaboutit enters the Dan Patch with two wins, two seconds and three thirds in his past seven races. Known for his fast-closing style, the 6-year-old gelding has come home faster than :26 seconds four times during that span, including his last two starts.

"He's not won a lot, but he's raced decent heading into it," said Miller, who trains Tellmeaboutit and shares ownership with Twila Harts. "He likes chasing horses down, sometimes he just has a little too much work to do.

"I think he will be coming with his 'A' game. I think he's ready. Like most of them in there, he's going to need a little luck with a trip."

Tellmeaboutit is a son of Tellitlikeitis—Portia Blue Chip, with his mom being a half-sister to millionaire Hypnotic Blue Chip. Tellmeaboutit has won 24 of 78 career races, hit the board a

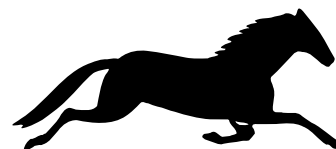

total of 63 times, and earned \$732,065. He was an Indiana Sire Stakes champion at ages 3 and 4. He was purchased for \$25,000 at the 2017 Hoosier Sale.

"He's one of them that everybody wants or would like to have," Miller said. "For a local horse, he's been a pretty nice one. We just basically race in Indiana. We venture out to Ohio every once in a while, but that's about as far as we go.

"He's a pleasure to have around. He's a nice horse to deal with on a daily basis."

Tellmeaboutit was the only horse in last year's Dan Patch with odds greater than 25-1, and Miller himself admitted having little hope.

"Honestly, I didn't think we had any kind of a shot out of the nine hole," Miller said. "But they raced aggressively on the front end, and it worked to his favor. It was his kind of race. Obviously, he's a closer. But he always gives you an effort.

"We need similar kind of luck. We just have to hope it sets up right. You never know."

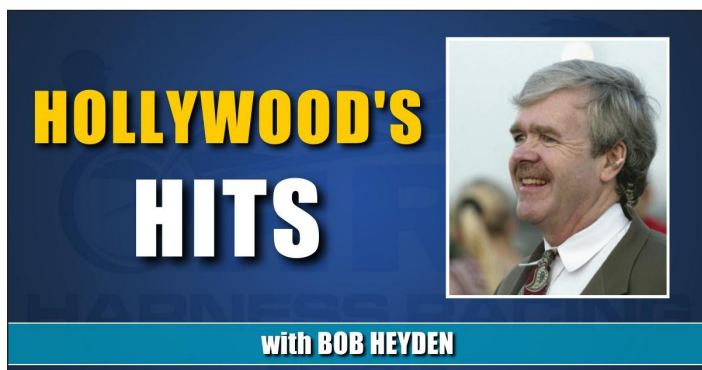

28 editions, 28 Dan Patch facts

1. With Catch The Fire not among tonight's field of 10, this marks the 20th defending Dan Patch champion who will not be in it the following season. No horse has ever won this back to back or twice.

2. Trace Tetrack will try to get on the Dan Patch board with his record 14th consecutive drive. He broke a tie with Ricky Macomber last year at 12 each.

3. The sport of harness racing did not have a sub-1:47 mile last year. Cattlewash came into the Dan Patch with a 1:46.4 mark set the year prior.

4. Tough race to win? Yes. Never has the Horse of the Year won the Dan Patch the same year he was voted the nation's top horse.

In 1994, the 1993 HOY Staying Together was fourth.

In 2016, the 2015 HOY Wiggle It Jiggleit was the winner.

In 2016, the 2016 HOY Always B Miki was second.

In 2019, the 2019 HOY McWicked was second (also, third and fourth, the two previous years, respectively).

5. Other notables who did not win the Dan Patch:
Foiled Again. He has one try, at age 11 in 2015 and was sixth as the 302 favorite.

Freaky Feet Pete made two appearances and was sixth and ninth.
Western Dreamer, the 1997 Triple Crown winner, was last in 1998.

6. Track records set in the Dan Patch:
1:50 1995 Pacific Rocket.

1:49.4 1996 Jennas Beach Boy

1:48.2 1998 Pacific Fella

1:47.2 2014 Sweet Lou

These are outright new records only. Five horses currently co-hold the track standard at 1:47.2 and one of them set it in the Dan Patch – Little Rocket Man (2020)

7. The 1994 Dan Patch on Nov. 12 was the very first Hoosier Park race simulcast to other outlets (won by Ready To Rumble).

8. Dave Miller will celebrate a 25th anniversary of sorts when he drives in 2022. He was second in 1997 to Hot Lead with Armbro Operative.

9. Dexter Dunn was second with 4-5 favorite Bettors Wish in 2020. He will try and breakthrough in 2022 with Bulldog Hanover.

10. Shady Daisy would have been the lone female to go in the Dan Patch but was scratched in 1994.

11. Alvin Miller, trainer of Tellmeaboutit, had 12 years between Dan Patch starters from 2009 to 2021. He was fourth with Rocket Fuel and then second with longshot Tellmeaboutit, who came into the 2021 Dan Patch off a lifetime mark and very nearly pulled off the huge upset.

12. Mike Oosting debuted at age 59 last year with Tellmeaboutit (second). Veteran Sam Widger has driven the two longest shots in Dan Patch history.

13. Won The West had a record four straight Dan Patch appearances from 2008-2011 (1-7-2-6).

14. Favorites are 12-for-28 in the Dan Patch. Never have the three favorites gone 1-2-3 in any Dan Patch.

15. Yannick Gingras is the only driver to win this back to back and did it from post nine each time – 2017 with Check Six and 2018 with Lazarus N.

16. Thirty-six times a Breeders Crown winner has raced in the Dan Patch and eight have won.

17. Twenty-three different drivers have won a Dan Patch.
18. In 23 of the 28 Dan Patch editions, the first quarter was the fastest of the race – and only three of 23 held on to win.

19. Only once has a father-son combo each won the Dan Patch – 1998 Pacific Fella and 2007 Artistic Fella.

20. Ron Burke has twice before had five in the Dan Patch. 2015: 2-3-5-6-8 and 2020: 3-4-6-7-10.

He now will have started a record 35 in the Dan Patch.

21. Mickey Burke and Ron Burke have each won this twice. Maltese Artist 2005 and Won The West 2008 for dad and 2017 Check Six and 2014 Sweet Lou for Ron.

22. Record Dan Patch fractions:
:24.4 Filibuster Hanover fifth in 2019

:52.2 Izatiger eighth in 1998

1:20.1 Sweet Lou the 2014 winner

1:47.2 Sweet Lou in 2014 and Lather Up in 2019

23. Bulldog Hanover is going to try and duplicate what has been done twice – world record race mile and then set a track record.

In 1996, Jennas Beach Boy won with a 1:47.3 mile at the Meadowlands and then his next race was 14 days later in the Dan Patch where he lowered the track record 1/5th to 1:49.4.

In 2019, Lather Up tied the world race record of 1:46 at the Meadowlands on July 6, then 34 days later came to Hoosier Park and equaled the Sweet Lou stakes and track record of 1:47.2 winning the Dan Patch over soon-to-be HOY Always B Miki.

24. In both Ron Burke's Dan Patch wins he went 1-2 or 1-2-3 in 2014 and 2017.

25. Bulldog Hanover is trying to become the first Dan Patch winner to be Horse of the Year the same year.

26. When Lather Up set his world record-tying 1:46 in July 2019, sitting right behind him in the three-hole was This Is The Plan who wound up second in a photo. The rare horse to compete against two world record setters.

27. Shark Gesture won by a stakes best 10 and a half lengths in 2010 for Ray/Larry Remmen.

28. Rosemary Noonan is the only female trainer to have won the Dan Patch 2004 Luckyisasluckydoes

The \$300,000 invitational honors Northfield Park's former owner.

Trainer Brian Brown has made some recent equipment adjustments and is looking for great things from Night Hawk, who has been tapped at the 4-1 second choice in the morning line for Saturday night's (Aug. 13) \$300,000 Carl Milstein Memorial Invitational for 3-year-old colt pacers at MGM Northfield Park.

The sophomore son of Betting Line is co-owned by the Leeman Lombardo Stable, Joe Sbrocco, In The Gym Partners and Acadia Farms.

Night Hawk has danced in almost all of the big events so far this season — finishing fifth in the \$770,000 North America Cup final (June 18), fourth in the \$600,000 Meadowlands Pace final (July 16) and third in the \$258,300 Cane Pace (Aug. 6).

"He's been in most of them. We skipped the Adios with him just because he raced (so much) and just to give him a little break," said Brown. "He raced good last week (in the Cane Pace final), but I think he should be better and finish stronger, so we are changing his bridle, going to close him up a little."

Brown and Night Hawk may have already won one of the biggest events this week, the post position draw. Night Hawk, who will be driven by Ohio native David Miller, will leave from post position #1.

"We were lucky enough to get the rail. We are in a good spot," said Brown. "You hope for the rail every

time you enter at Northfield, whether it is a non-winners of one or this race."

Night Hawk, a \$35,000 yearling purchase at the Lexington Select Sale, was lightly raced at 2. He won both of his freshman starts in Pennsylvania Sire Stakes action earning \$54,219 and taking a mark of 1:52 at Harrah's Philadelphia.

"He was sore in the hind cannon bone," said Brown. "We tried to swim him, but as soon as I trained him, he would get sore."

Night Hawk has pushed his career earnings to just under \$250,000. He was second in the first PASS leg at The Meadows and took his 1:48.4 career best mark in the second sire stakes leg at Pocono Downs — a neck win over Mad Max Hanover.

"He was terrific that day," said Brown. "He hasn't been as sharp since that day. We are trying to change things. After that start I went to aluminum (shoes) and I don't think he liked them. We took them off and he was really good gaited at the Meadowlands, I think we are going in the right direction."

The Ohio bred, Bythemissal (7-5 morning line) comes into the invitational off the \$350,000 Adios Pace final and Ohio State Fair wins — in 1:48.3 and 1:49.3 respectively. The Downbytheseaside gelding has won seven of his eight career starts. His only blemish on his card is a second-place finish to Pebble Beach in their Adios elimination. Bythemissal will be piloted by Chris Page for trainer Ron Burke and his owners — Burke Racing Stable, Eric Good, Rich Lombardo Racing and Weaver Brusceini.

Bythemissal's stablemate JK Victory (Ronnie Wrenn, Jr. — Post #4) is the third choice in the morning line at 9-2. The Indiana-bred gelded son of Jk Endofanera has been first or second in each of his seven seasonal starts and has nearly \$200,000 in career earnings. Ron Burke trains for the 3 Brothers Stable and Caviart Farms.

"The mile Bythemissal went at The Meadows was a hell of a mile. To come first up and just ride out there from the half on," said Brown. "At Scioto, he just jogged a mile in (1):49.3."

The race honors Carl Milstein, who owned Northfield Park from 1984 until his passing in 1999. The Milstein family operated the track until July 2018.

The Milstein undercard features a pair of \$100,000 invitational events restricted to Ohio-bred older horses and a pair of Ohio Sire Stake divisions for three-year-old colt trotters.

The Tom Aldrich President's Trot will feature a nine of the state's best performers – Refined (Matt Kakaley – Post #5), Herculisa (Brett Miller – Post #7) and It's Academic (David Miller – Post #9) are expected to take much of the betting action.

The Myron Charna Invitational Pace looks to be a wide open affair. Northfield Park based One Last Laugh (Hunter Myers) drew the rail spot and is the field's third richest performer in 2022. Breeders Crown champion Ocean Rock (David Miller – Post #5) returns to the 'Flying Turns' and Charlie May (Brett Miller) continues his streak of post position draws in big Northfield stakes by drawing the trailing post #9.

Trainer Chris Beaver and driver Aaron Merriman swept the Ohio State Fair Stakes last week with Gabbys Bit Coin and Caviar Gold, but both colts will have to start from the outside post #8 in each of their \$55,000 divisions of the OhSS for sophomore male trotters.

The post time for the 16-race card is 6 p.m.

SIRES STAKES REPORT

Favorites toppled in NY Sire Stakes on Tuesday at Yonkers

A 67-1 shocker by **Stretch The Line** was followed by 5-1 shot **Roll With The Flow** winning in a pair of New York Sire Stakes splits for 3-year-old colt and gelding pacers on Tuesday night (Aug. 9) at Yonkers Raceway.

JD (Mark MacDonald) was the 1-5 favorite in the first \$87,000 division, and he would take the lead away from Blue Collar Man (Dan Daley) heading to the :27.3 opening quarter. JD then backed down the half to :56.4, but Lannister Hanover (Pat Lachance) began a first-over move out of third going to that marker, advanced steadily on the rim, and joined JD on the front-end heading to the 1:25 three-quarters. Twin B Deluxe (Jason Bartlett) was behind Lannister Hanover in the second-over position, and Stretch The Line (Marcus Miller) worked out a third-over journey.

Lannister Hanover and JD continued to duel around the last turn, but JD dug in gamely to repel Lannister Hanover's bid and turned into the lane first. Twin B Deluxe was out and rolling three-wide, though, with Stretch The Line tracking him before being angled out four-wide by Miller in the stretch.

Through the drive JD continued to respond determinedly to MacDonald's encouragement, and weathered the bid of Twin B Deluxe, but Stretch The Line had all the momentum to Twin B Deluxe's outside and hit the wire a head in front of JD in a 1:53.4 mile. Twin B Deluxe had to settle for third.

Stretch The Line is a Huntsville gelding owned by trainer Erv Miller in partnership with Rock And Roll Stable Inc. Stretch The Line, who was bred by Eric Taddeo, won for the sixth time from 16 career starts, has now earned \$115,963, and paid \$136.50 to win. The exacta was worth \$330.50 and the trifecta kicked back \$2,575.00.

In the second \$85,500 grouping, Kingsville (Dan Dube) hustled to early command from post four but would be overtaken by Seven Hundred (George Brennan) prior to the 27.1 opening quarter. Seven Hundred kept the tempo lively after hitting the front, reaching the half in 55.3 and the three-quarters in 1:23.3.

Meanwhile, Roll With The Flow (MacDonald) watched the action from fourth but got going first-over in the third quarter, and when he collared Seven Hundred on the last turn, Seven Hundred couldn't fend him off. Roll With The Flow would then kick clear after dispatching Seven Hundred, reaching the wire two lengths ahead of Huntanover (Tyler Buter) in a final time

of 1:53 flat. Flip My Chip (Miller) closed from sixth to third in the final quarter.

A gelding by Roll With Joe bred by Winbak Farm, Roll With The Flow is trained by Jessica Fallon for owners Hutt Racing Stable, Middlebrook Racing L.P., and Blake MacIntosh. Roll With The Flow has compiled a record of 6-5-2 from 21 lifetime tries, and he pushed his bankroll to \$126,220. Roll With The Flow returned \$12.00 to win and keyed a \$39.60 exacta and a \$431.00 trifecta.

On the undercard there were two \$15,000 New York Excelsior "A" Series tests for sophomore male pacers, and getting the victories were **Bluesville** (by Huntsville and bred by Fred Hertrich III) in 1:53.2 for driver Tyler Buter, trainer George Ducharme, and owner Purple Haze Stables LLC., and **Shakertown** (by American Ideal and bred by Fair Winds Farm) in 1:52.3 for driver Jason Bartlett, trainer Tony Alagna, and owners Crawford Farms Racing and Alan Johnston.

Yonkers will welcome the New York Sire Stakes circuit back to Westchester on Aug. 23 when the 2-year-old colt and gelding trotters compete in their sixth preliminary leg.

Vivians Dream shines in NYSS at Batavia

A total of \$104,000 was up for grabs for the 10 participating 2-year-old pacing fillies who were on hand for the New York Sire Stakes at Batavia Downs on Wednesday evening (Aug. 10).

The \$52,500 second division was scratched down to a field of five and **Vivians Dream** (American Ideal—Sports Chic) put on quite a show.

Vivians Dream (Jordan Stratton) left sharply and grabbed the lead as soon as the gate closed. With Hunting Season (Mark Macdonald) and Rock My Socks (Jason Bartlett) following loosely in second and third, Stratton snuggled-up Vivians Dream and got away with a very pedestrian :59 half and that strategy ended up paying big dividends.

When the race made its way onto the second circuit, the pace picked up substantially and Vivians Dream was starting to separate from the field. She got to three-quarters in 1:26.4, rounded the last turn and opened up by 3-1/4 lengths at the top of the stretch. From there she blazed home in :27.1 to win easily in 1:54.

It was the fifth win in only six lifetime starts for Vivians Dream (\$2.50) and owner Forrest Bartlett. Cory Mumford trains the winner. Vivians Dream was bred at Winbak Farm.

Jordan Stratton ended the night with three driving wins.

In the first \$51,500 division, Dame (Dude's The Man-Seat By The Window) made every station a winning one en route to a new lifetime mark.

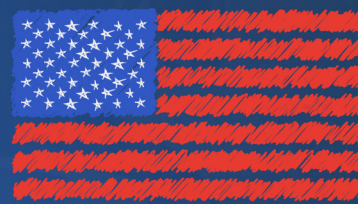
Luke Hanners held position with Dame from post one and became the commander of fractions after the post time favorite Doing Marvelous (Jordan Stratton) made a break trying for the front. Tom Jackson records 5,000th driving victory

Tom Jackson recorded the 5000th victory of his driving career when he brought home the Trixton–Angel Eyes Hanover freshman Saint Trixie to victory in the fourth race at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono on Tuesday afternoon (Aug. 9).

Jackson and trainer Fred Grant have had outstanding success for two 20-year-old trotting fillies over the last few weeks, and here Saint Trixie was recording her second straight triumph, sitting in the pocket then rallying to a new mark of 1:56.4 over sloppy going for Jackson and Grant.

It's hard to believe that the youthful-looking Jackson, 59, is in his sixth decade of driving, but he began his career in 1979 (when his sulky appearances accounted for purses of \$607). He was a leading driver in his native state of Maryland before making the move to Pennsylvania when the purses grew with the introduction of further gaming, and he has been a mainstay of the local horsemen's community since, with some wintering in Florida. Jackson's USTA record also shows him with 488 training wins, although he likely had quite a few more before trainers' records were started by the USTA in 1991.

Tom followed his father Hubert into the harness business; Hubert, known as the "King of Queen Anne" because of his Maryland birthplace, was one of the top horsemen on the Delmarva peninsula, recording over 1000 wins in the USTA computer although he almost certainly had many more that have gone unrecorded. After winning with a two-year-old in 1:58 in June a few years ago, Tom was asked what he thought Hubert might say about going so fast with a baby, and Tom replied, "He probably would have handed me a pitchfork, pointed me to the barn, and told me not to come out for a month."

Pocono's leading driver, Matt Kakaley, also had a "milestone win" of sorts – he drove his first winner since being injured in a racing accident here on July 26, putting a new mark of 1:57 (track updated to "good") on The American Eagle. (He would later add a second win with another trotter, Say You Do, in 1:55.) Kakaley had a 177-160 edge in wins over perennial Pocono leader George Napolitano Jr. as of the start of the Tuesday's action.

Bythemissal highlights \$300,000 Carl Milstein Memorial Saturday at MGM Northfield Park

This year's Adios victor Bythemissal has been named the 7-5 morning line favorite in Saturday's (Aug. 13) \$300,000 Carl Milstein Memorial at MGM Northfield Park. The Buckeye-bred headlines an accomplished group of nine 3-year-old pacers in Northfield Park's premier event.

The Milstein, a race by invitation only, is slated as race 10 on an impressive 16-race program, with purses more than \$700,000. First-race post time is 6 p.m.

A son of Downbytheseaside (winner of the 2017 Milstein), Bythemissal would make consecutive years that an Ohio-bred was victorious against open company in this event. Charlie May won the Milstein last year and will race as the prohibitive favorite in the \$100,000 President's Pace, a race for older Ohio-sired pacers (by invitation only) on the undercard.

Bythemissal has won seven of eight career races and enters off scores in the \$350,000 Adios at The Meadows and \$65,000 Ohio State Fair at Scioto Downs. The Ron Burke trainee has banked \$285,250 in purses throughout his young career and drew post five in Saturday's main event for owners Burke Racing Stable, Eric Good, Rich Lombardo Racing and Weaver Brussemi LLC. Bythemissal's regular pilot, Chris Page, will drive.

Night Hawk drew the rail and is the 4-1 second choice. He has won three of nine races this year and just finished third in the \$258,300 Cane Pace at The Meadowlands. He has finished in the top three seven times this year. His 1:48.4 mark was paced at Pocono Downs, winning his division of the \$46,386 Pennsylvania Sire Stakes. Night Hawk has earned \$193,653 this year for owners Leeman Lombardo Stable, Joe Sbrocco, In The Gym Partners and Acadia Farms. He is trained at the historic Delaware County Fairgrounds by Brian Brown, who called upon David Miller to drive.

JK Victory, winner of this year's \$70,000 Hoosier Cup, drew post four and is the 9-2 third choice. JK Victory has been first or second in each of his seven starts this year and has earned \$134,750. This is the second entry for Ron Burke, harness racing's all-time leading trainer, who conditions the horse for 3 Brothers Stables and Caviart Farms. Ronnie Wrenn Jr. will drive.

Delaware standout Heinikin Bythebay (Tim Tetrick, 10-1), Indiana heavy-hitters Soaring Now (Joey Putnam, 8-1) and Ponda Warrior (Jimmy Whitemore 20-1), New York standouts Pleaseletmeknow (Matt Kakaley, 6-1) and Layton Hanover (Chris Lems, 15-1) and exceptional Canadian Sport Secret (Douglas McNair, 12-1) are also slated starters in the impressive field.

The race is named in honor of Carl Milstein, who owned Northfield Park from 1984 until his death in 1999. Brock Milstein and the Milstein family operated Northfield Park until July 2018, when MGM Growth Properties purchased the racetrack from Milstein Entertainment, LLC.

The 16-race program includes the \$100,000 Myron Charna President's Pace, a race for older Ohio-sired pacers (by invitation only), the \$100,000 Tom Aldrich President's Trot, a race for older Ohio-sired trotters (by invitation only) and two \$55,000 divisions of Ohio Sires Stakes for 3-year-old trotting colts and geldings.

Saturday's wagering menu includes a \$20,000 guaranteed all-stakes \$1.00 Pick 5 (Race 6), a \$15,000 guaranteed \$1.00 Late Pick 4 (Race 11) and a \$15,000 guaranteed 20-cent Super High-5 (Race 13). All guaranteed wagers are in conjunction with the USTA's Strategic Wagering Program.

Dr. Karyn Malinowski receives HHYF Service To Youth Award

Dr. Karyn Malinowski, Director of the Equine Science Center at Rutgers, recently received the Harness Horse Youth Foundation's 2021 Service To Youth Award at The Meadowlands Racetrack in East Rutherford, NJ. She was surrounded by her colleagues and friends.

Dr. Malinowski is an accomplished equine scientist, a Professor of Animal Science, and is the Founding Director of the Rutgers Equine Science Center at the New Jersey Agricultural Experiment Station (NJAES).

She has served as a faculty member at the School of Environmental and Biological Sciences since 1978 in various roles including: Extension Specialist in Equine Sciences, Animal Sciences Professor, Founding Director of the Equine Science Center, and Director of Rutgers Cooperative Extension. Her research and extension programs concentrate on improving the well-being and quality of life of the equine athlete while ensuring the vitality and viability of the equine industry, both statewide and nationally. She played a lead role in building the equine science program at Rutgers University and in the formation of the Rutgers Equine Science Center.

Dr. Malinowski is the author of over 50 refereed journal articles and abstracts, and numerous book chapters. Her expertise in the area of aging and stress management in horses has resulted in her speaking at numerous international venues, and her extension project entitled, "Careers in the Green Industry: Youth Sow Seeds for Their Future," which involved horses and adjudicated youth, has served as a model for similar programs around the world.

In addition, Malinowski was a member of the team which conducted the prize-winning study, The New Jersey Equine Industry 2007: Economic Impact which has been used by the New Jersey horse industry to show its value to the Garden State.

Malinowski has spent much of her career working with youth in 4-H programs and developed with her students and staff the famous website portal, "Equine Science 4 Kids" which is enjoyed by youth around the globe as they learn about the basics in caring for and managing horses.

Long overdue, this award to Dr. Malinowski is a small recognition for her career-long dedication and efforts on behalf of youth, college students and the Standardbred industry.
