Is there a more unique situation in horsedom than that which Tony Alagna shares with his mom Donna Lee? One would be inclined to think not. Alagna's rise in harness racing has been nothing less than meteoric, although it has taken more time than this scribe initially thought.

In October of 2009, Alagna, then working with Erv Miller, decided that it was time to spread his wings and fly on his own. He started with about a dozen horses under his care. The training empire under his control now extends to between 100 and 120 horses.

Alagna's mom, Donna Lee, had been struggling In Illinois' faltering harness racing industry until she decided to make a break and join her son's team.

"I had done all the bookkeeping from the time that he started," Lee said. "He said, 'Don't worry mom, I'll never have more than 30 head."

At that time, Alagna had approximately 20 horses under his care.

"I was definitely the employee, not the employer. It used to be the opposite. Nevertheless, I felt that Tony needed me and that I hopefully could be of help to him and his operation. I feel that the arrangement has worked out well for both of us.

"At that time, there was no defined role for me in the operation. I feel that I helped where help was needed in just about every phase of the operation. Did Tony need a rider? I was available. Did he need someone to take charge of the bookkeeping? I was there. Could I help with client relationships? I was available."

A unique situation developed in 2015. Tony had several Canadian owners as well as Ontario-bred horses in the stable. He asked if Donna Lee would take a draft of horses to Canada and set up camp there during the warm weather part of the racing season. Why not? When Donna Lee and the author spoke, she had 15 head under her care. She anticipated that the number would rise to close to 30 once the Grand Circuit racing began.

Q: How do you manage with the ebb and flow associated with having changing numbers of horses under your care? Next week you will likely have twice as many here as you do today.

"We cope as it becomes necessary. The biggest problem is in securing and retaining enough good help. That isn't a problem

unique to us. It's pervasive throughout the business. We pay well in Canada — \$150 per horse and \$150 paddocks. However, being a caretaker isn't the easiest job in the world. The most difficult part of it are the hours, more specifically the need to work seven day weeks and often going without a break from the grind."

Q: How often do you speak with your son?

"Every single day. More often than not as many as four or five different times a day. I have to say, though, that my son, at the fear of giving him a swelled head, is an extremely unique person. He personifies the term workaholic. He is on top of everything that is happening whether it be with the horses, the staff, the owners and sometimes even with me. He has a photographic memory. You don't have to tell him anything more than once. Once it enters that mind of his, it is there forever. He knows every horse of his as well as a good many from elsewhere on sight. Not only does he know them, but he also knows the equipment they wear and their likes and dislikes. He doesn't miss anything. I don't know how he manages to do everything that he does. in addition to all the horse-related areas, he is also a great people person. It seems he is always available to speak with the numerous owners in the stable."

Q: How many owners do you have in the stable?

"Right now the number is 64. It might range from a person who has a small percentage of one horse to an individual who has interests in as many as 20 or even more."

Q: Have you developed relationships with any of the owners in the stable?

"Tony speaks with the owners far more than I do. I'm fairly close with and speak to Al Saul of the Big Al's Stable quite a



bit. I'm guessing that part of it is that he is a Canadian and lives here. He enjoys being with and around his horses. We speak often. Another owner in the stable with whom I've become friends with is Dr Richard Gordon. 'Gordo' as he is sometimes called owns small parts of two horses in the stable, but he is as enthusiastic about harness racing as just about anybody as I've ever known. The strange part of our relationship is that I speak with him and a few other horse people often and regard him as a friend, but we've never actually met. I had some serious health issues this last year. Dr. Gordon was invaluable in furnishing information and lending support. Other owners with whom I've become friendly are John Fodera, Steve Wienick, Sam Bowie and of course Myron."

Q: Can you expound on the health issues?

"One word cancer. I was diagnosed with it this past winter. I was operated on and had the upper lobe of my left lung removed on March 8. That took place after nine and a half weeks of chemo and radiation while in Florida. Tony, the great son that he is, came down to take care of me. I told him at the time that I'd be back and riding within 30 days. I guess I lied. I was back in the office in 10 days and back in the bike in 31 days.

Q: Let's talk some about the horses. Who is your favorite?

"That would undoubtedly be Caprice Hill. I had her from the time she was a yearling until she retired from racing. She was sweet, highly intelligent and really loved to race. If any of the other horses in the stable was scheduled to race when she wasn't, she would carry on to no end. She wanted her share of the action. Another of my favorites is Dr J Hanover. When he was done racing, he was given to me as a riding horse. He is part of my menagerie which includes one other horse retiree and my faithful dog Freckles. Freckles and Dr J have something in common. They are both fat and lazy."

Q: What about your team? How many people do you have working with you?


"It can vary from week to week. It is always subject to change. Many of our caretakers are of Hispanic background and have been with us for some time. Tony has a big edge in that area. He is quite fluent in Spanish and is able to converse well with them. Another indispensable associate of ours is Hall of Famer Cat Manzi who has now been with us for four years. We added another great component this past season when Jan Johnson, a man with Hall of Fame credentials joined the team. He stayed in Florida with me overseeing the horses we had down there this past winter."

Q: How did that work out for you? This was the first time that Tony had his stable split into two segments.

"I thought it worked out just fine. It was a bit of an adjustment, though. Jan and I were in charge in Florida. Tony would come down every two weeks. It worked smoothly. Playing results, it appears that we are having a banner year with our 2-year-olds. We split the babies and the 3-year-olds evenly between Florida and New Jersey."

Q: That brings up the question of what you guys will be doing this coming season. Will you do what you did last year and maintain a two-pronged presence or will you stay up north with all the horses?

"Tony hasn't yet decided. Of course the final decision will be up to him. If it were up to Jan and me, and I suppose a group of the owners, we would do what we did last year. We'd still keep the Florida operation going. It would probably be cheaper and maybe more efficient if everything remained at Tony's training center in New Jersey. Jan lives in Florida. I'm sure he'd be reluctant to leave. I own a condo in Florida. I suppose I could sell it, but I've grown used to the kind Florida weather. I'm not

Q: You've been coming up to Canada now for eight years. How do you like it?

"I like it a lot. I especially like the people. I find that, generally speaking, they are kind, friendly and helpful. The weather at this time of year is just fine. When our horses hit the racetrack, they are, in effect, ready to race, because there are no surprises. They know what it's all about. They've already done it."

Bulldog Hanover unleashes a jaw-dropping performance in the Dan Patch Stakes at Harrah's Hoosier Park

World champion **Bulldog Hanover** traveled back to Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino to take on nine rivals in the \$315,000 Dan Patch Stakes on Friday (Aug. 12) and delivered what the fans came to see — an authoritative 1:48.1 performance in front of a packed house. Finishing under wraps with Dexter Dunn in the bike, Bulldog Hanover cruised to a two and three-quarter length victory over Rockyroad Hanover and Todd McCarthy.

It was Bulldog Hanover's first performance since his 1:45.4 world-record win in the William Haughton Memorial four weeks ago. With the victory, Bulldog Hanover recorded his seventh straight victory and stamped his name in the Harrah's Hoosier Park record books.

Leaving from post three in the talented field of 10, Dunn sent Bulldog Hanover away from the gate to grab a spot along the rail in third. David Miller had Workin On A Mystery pointed to the front and they grabbed the early lead through the opening panel in :26. This Is The Plan and Yannick Gingras also left sharply to grab a pocket seat from post nine while the rest of the field sorted out early position.

Approaching the half, Bulldog Hanover was given the green light and he powered up to take the lead at the second station in :54.3.

From there, he began to put his talent on display. Reaching the three-quarters in 1:22.3, Bulldog Hanover was on top by a length and his lead was ever-increasing. Rockyroad Hanover was on the attack from first-over but would have too much work to do. Using a :25.3 closing kick, Bulldog Hanover simply paced away from the field to reach the wire in front. Rockyroad Hanover was forced to settle for second place honors while Workin Ona Mystery held on for third. As the 1-5 favorite, Bulldog Hanover returned \$2.40 to his backers at the betting windows.

"Working with a horse like him makes my job very easy," said Dunn. "We got away cleanly and handily, and once I moved him, I had a handful of horse. The further he seems to go, the better he is. He's putting in these big miles and going fast times and it really doesn't seem to be bothering him. He bounces back and does it again and again.

"There was never really an anxious moment. I knew with the way he felt it was going to take a pretty big effort from one of the others to chase him down. He did it pretty easy tonight."

Trainer Jack Darling made the trip with his stable standout and was on hand in the winner's circle.

"He doesn't take a lot of maintenance," he said. "His caretaker is with him all the time and we just try to do what we can to keep him happy We love it here at Hoosier (Harrah's Hoosier Park) and Bulldog likes it too. He has another start here in a few weeks so we will be back. He's got the Canadian Pacing Derby up next in two weeks at Mohawk and then we will be back here for the Hoosier Park Pacing Derby."

With the victory, Bulldog Hanover received an automatic nomination to the 2022 edition of the \$175,000 Hoosier Park Pacing Derby slated for Saturday, Sept. 23. Bulldog Hanover is now undefeated in five starts over the Hoosier Park oval. The victory was the first Dan Patch win for trainer Darling and driver Dunn. Bulldog Hanover is owned in partnership by Jack Darling Stables LTD and Bradley Grant. The son of Shadow Play—Bj's Squall has now won 22 of 29 lifetime starts and pushed his lifetime bankroll to \$1,431,025.

The race proved to be the perfect ending to a sensational evening of harness racing in front of a packed house for the 29th edition of Harrah's Hoosier Park's premier harness racing event. The evening's 15-race card produced a Dan Patch record handle of \$1,568,105, besting the total handle of \$1,481,330 from 2021.



The more things change...

The French are right: "Le plus ça change, le plus c'est la meme." The more things change, the more they stay the same.

That was exactly the case on Hambletonian day at The Meadowlands. The transplanted Swedish horsemen showed their clout in both the stakes for 2-year-old trotters. Kilmister won the \$337,000 Peter Haughton for Marcus Melander over his stablemate, Oh Well, and Instagram Model took the \$335,000 Jim Doherty for 2-year-old trotting fillies.

But the two big dances went to the eccentrically hatted Jim Campbell, an Ontario native and long-time New Jersey resident. His longshot gelding Cool Papa Bell got a one-in-a-million drive from Todd McCarthy to win the Hambletonian, and his Fashion Schooner was sharp as a knife to win the Oaks.


So if you're trying to make a decision about a trotting trainer, the answer is you won't go wrong with either choice, North American or Swedish American. No one group or nationality has an exclusive on good horsemen.

What Hambletonian day also crystallized was the dominance of trotting sire Chapter Seven. If I had my druthers, I'd wish a less fraught name for such a great horse, but maybe a rose by any other name would actually smell just as sweet.

I do take some pride in Chapter Seven's pedigree, as his tail male (or top line) grandsire is Conway Hall, whom my wife Meg and I bred. His great grandsire is Garland Lobell, bred by yours truly, and on back to Noble Victory, the first million dollar standardbred when I syndicated him in 1964, better known as the Ming Dynasty.

Like a lot of trotters today, Chapter Seven has no close crosses in his pedigree. His first four generations have no duplicate names, making him technically an Outcross.

In case you forgot, when the sum of the generations in which the same name appears twice is six or less, that is defined as Inbreeding.

When the sum of the generations in which the same name appears twice is seven or eight, that is defined as Line Breeding.

When there is no common name that appears twice in the first four generations, that is technically defined as an Outcross.

Chapter Seven is an outcross, as are a great majority of the American Trotting breed today. What this means is there is no danger lurking ahead in the form of compromised stallion fertility, such as we experienced some 30 years ago.

What we lived through then was the result of inbreeding to the extent that the American trotter lost 17 per cent of its heterozygosity, or the variability factor. The first manifestation of that condition is the loss of stallion fertility, as all of us who struggled with sons and grandsons vividly remember.

Not only does Chapter Seven have a totally Outcross pedigree, so does his fast, gelding son Cool Papa Bell. (In case you don't know your baseball, James Thomas Bell, aka Cool Papa, was a star of the Negro Baseball League. Because of his color, he never played in organized, white baseball. In 1974, he was elected to the Baseball Hall of Fame.)

Forgive a personal note here. I was thrilled for Todd McCarthy, a new friend, who maybe will do a redux next year with a colt I'm close to.

Cool Papa Bell's pedigree has no close crosses whatever, except for the influence of another great ball player, Charlie Keller. Two of the granddams on both sides of his pedigree go straight back to their granddam, Yankee Duchess.

Yankee Duchess is a daughter of China L, the first mare Keller ever bought. He paid \$1,600 for her at one of Joe Eyler's auctions at Thurmont, MD. Eyler got Keller into our business after the latter retired from baseball.

China L was a great bred mare whom Eyler had begged into the sale from an understanding executor of the W. N. Reynolds Estate. Keller could not only have bought his foundation mare that afternoon, he could have also bought a push lawn mower, a bicycle sans hub caps, and several bags rumored to contain dog food, with nothing guaranteed.

When Joe Eyler put on a sale, there was something for everyone. Although it was not exactly last week, I still remember it well because I was standing close to Keller and Jim Harrison when he bought his new vocation.



Finally, I ask an indulgence. I was watching Hambletonian Day on RTN, and during the warm-ups for the big dance, the camera at one point fastened on Tim Tetrick and Rebuff.

As a horseman, I can instantly spot a pair of good hands, as Tetrick is blessed with. The camera caught him barely tightening the lines, starting from a walk, and then stayed with the two of them as Rebuff effortlessly changed gears a he hit his full stride.

And what I saw then was something of incredible beauty. Rebuff was trotting the way every horseman's dream horse trots. So it doesn't matter to me that Rebuff didn't get any money in the race that counts more than any other race. Just as it won't matter to this kid if he doesn't win another race in his life.

I'm saying right here and now that Rebuff is going to be the world's next great trotting sire. And if I happen to be wrong, feel free to tell me so, assuming you're able to find me, which by then I seriously doubt, but good luck trying.



"Although none of my family was involved in harness racing, my mother and I competed at high levels in equestrian riding. My career in harness racing started when I jogged a horse one day for people who lived behind me, and it was all over. I was immediately hooked and that's all I wanted to do.

"I began working for Australian trainers Josh and Terry Ball before and after school at their farm. They eventually gave me my first two race drives, where I finished first and second.

"I love to drive. I've driven in three countries, every state in Australia, the north and south island of New Zealand and now in the United States."

Married to Shane Tritton, also a trainer, the couple train as a team.

Currently stabled at the Pine Bush Training Facility in Pinebush, NY, the Trittons currently operate a stable of 20 but are hoping to increase that number to 30.

"At one time, my husband and I were training 93 horses in Australia. It was a tough lifestyle for we are the parents of two small children and we like to spend a lot of time with them."

As for some of her awards and driving highlights, Tritton said, "I have won the drivers premiership twice. I was the first female to win the open premiership, the youngest driver to win 500 races and I drove four winners at one meeting 21 times."

As far as her fastest drive, it was 1:48.3 with a horse named Anything For Love at Menangle in Australia. And in the United States she won with Springsteen in 1:50.4 at Tioga Downs. He just happens to be her all time favorite horse.

On July 13, 2022, Tritton finished second with 2-year-old coll It's a Me Mario in the New York Sires Stakes at Buffalo Raceway. The time of the race was 1:55.1— a new track record.

But her most thrilling times in the sport was winning the International Monte Trot under saddle and coming back to win a race in the bike the next race.

Tritton does it all. She trains, drives, rides under saddle and is a wife and mother. She drives both trotters and pacers — preferring pacers.

"There is nothing better than to sit behind a nice trotter."

Her resume is strong for Tritton's won over a dozen Grand Circuit races, including some of Australia's biggest mile races: including the Breeders Crown by three lengths on Marty Monkhouser A and the Victorian Derby with Muscle Factory A (which is equivalent to the Meadowlands Pace).

Tritton has represented her state and Australia driving championships, won the award for "most successful UDR" and has been the leading driver at three different tracks.




WHY ARE THE MCCARTHYS AND DUNN DOING SO WELL HERE?

Let the shows begin

The first NFL draft began on Feb. 8, 1936, at the Ritz Carlton Hotel in Philadelphia. The humble beginnings saw 90 names scribbled on a chalkboard. Relatively few people were interested in this process of selecting future sporting stars. There was no media coverage. Who would care?

Eighty-six years later, plenty of people care. Last year, 55 million people watched at least part of the three-day draft selection extravaganza. Despite no sporting activity, the NFL draft has evolved into an event. Other pro-sports followed suit and have draft fests of their own. Major League Baseball recently held its draft for players who will not be on the field for years.

Rebirth and renewed hope are the engines that drive draft mania

After your home team has a poor season, the draft is a bridge as you wait for next year. We are very similar in harness horse racing. After the disappointments of the previous year on the racetrack, we hold our annual drafts in the form of various yearling sales. Hope is in the air as the latest crop of standardbreds each step onto the stage, and we restock for next season.

Our current auctions of yearlings are fine. Videos and remote bidding are popular additions for people purchasing horses. Still,

sales companies may wish to evolve by looking at the success of our sporting brethren in the marketplace of future young stars.

In other drafts, there is an insatiable appetite for draft content blasted out by prognosticators, bloviators, gurus, analysts, and snake oil salesman. Our sport might benefit from more hoopla, people with robust options, predictions, mock drafts, pre-sales confabs, and all the things that make other sports buzz before the choices take place with great fanfare.

The popularity of sporting drafts snuck up on most of us. Few recognized the psychological power in sports drafts (and yearling sales) where everyone is hungry to make a fresh start. The human psyche seems to relish making exciting picks. Every year we believe this year we will find the one that changes everything, maybe the one that everyone else missed.

It is human nature to adopt prospects for emotional reasons. We enjoy being correct with these picks, being right early on, and believing we have value in our selections. And, of course, as in most things, the internet is an essential factor. Everyone can research and find hidden gems in the tsunami of data.

We need a few of these folks who are so confident they can't keep their choices to themselves to attract followings, start podcasts, and tout their wisdom and forward-thinking. It is fun to listen to characters claiming to be the most brilliant guys in the room who have access to all the "secret" research. Everybody's got an opinion to be validated or destroyed. The selection process can be dramatic and fun.

I have a pal who loves this pedigree stuff. In my opinion, he is damn good at picking yearlings. When a yearling catalog is released, each page gets a severe review, with notations, circles, yellow markers for emphasis, rating, grades, and many other things I do not understand. Then, he watches the videos and grades them. Then he looks for hidden material that is not on the hip page.

Last week Trey suggested a webinar with a couple of pedigree nerds. On the appointed day, he and another expert will review the Lexington trotting fillies. Then on another day, their webinar

will cover the pacing colts in the Ohio select sale, etc. They will go page by page, rating each horse from A to D, learning where they agree or disagree while educating and entertaining.

In addition to these webinars — the sales company should follow the lead of baseball, hockey, basketball, and even college sports and take it up a notch. Produce, or hire people to produce, shows leading up to the draft (sale), and then add more glitz for the patrons in the building and on the video stream. Auction companies could lean into drama, perhaps consider more time before and between horses, more pauses in the bidding action auction. Maybe some quick interviews after buyers sign the sales tickets, confetti cannons when a new sales topper sells, or drawings for credit vouchers and prizes every twenty sales. These are just a few ideas.

Why bother to change the formula?

People like a show, people like drama, and people enjoy the fun. At the core, this will still be an auction where good yearlings will sell for high prices, and lesser stock will struggle. Other sports realize the power of their drafts for their businesses. They are learning ways to capitalize on hopes, dreams, and data in a digital world. We can join them.

Osceola repeats, Dws Point Man posts debut win in OSS Gold action

Rookie trotting colts and geldings met up Friday evening (Aug. 12) at Woodbine Mohawk Park for the third Ontario Sires Stakes Gold leg of the season.

Team McNair's **Osceola** moved to the lead just after the opening-quarter and never looked back for a 1:56.1 victory in the \$101,300 first division. Doug McNair guided the son of Muscle Mass to victory for his father, trainer Gregg McNair.

"I just wanted to get around the first turn and go from there," said Doug McNair "I know he's got a ton of trot and once he made the lead I was pretty confident. He's a really nice colt, we've got no complaints, he's a great horse to sit behind." The race opened with Oh Look Magic posting a :28.4 first quarter. Once the field straightened out for the backstretch, McNair moved Osceola to the top from third and posted fractions of :59 and 1:28.1 to lead into the stretch. Ghostly Casper made a big move first up from sixth on the final turn and got to the leader's wheel, but Osceola wouldn't allow the rival to get any closer, closing out the mile in :28 to win by a length and a half.

Oh Look Magic and Dowedealinandwhy rounded out the topfour finishers.

After making a break in his career debut, Osceola has now rebounded for back-to-back OSS Gold victories, banking \$102,200 in the process for owners Gregg McNair, Willow Oak Ranch and Paul Hawman.

A \$2 win ticket on Osceola returned \$3.40.

The \$100,400 second division saw **Dws Point Man** make an immediate for new connections, posting a 1:57.1 score.

An early scramble for command saw rookies spread three-wide going into the first turn, as Snowpiercer held ground at the rail with Dws Point Man and Stonebridge Bomber stacked up. After a :28.2 opener, Stonebridge Bomber cleared Dws Point Man, but Snowpiercer swung back to the lead at a :58.3 half.

Snowpiercer got a jump on his rivals on the far turn, which forced Dws Point Man and driver Louis-Philippe Roy to make a

move outside to try and reel in the leader. After reaching threequarters in 1:28.2, Snowpiercer couldn't find enough to seal the deal, losing the lead to Dws Point Man. The new leader trotted strongly to the line for a win of just over a length. Deadline Hall split through to grab second, while Snowpiercer settled for third.

A gelded son of My MVP, Dws Point Man was recently purchased by Ecurie CSL and 9174 7998 Quebec Inc. after posting strong efforts in Saratoga, New York. Driver Roy noted that he played a role in helping the connections acquire Dws Point Man, who now races for trainer Richard Moreau.

"A friend of mine from Saratoga texted me about (Dws Point Man) and said the owner wants to sell him," said Roy. "I looked at him a little bit and I knew Sylvain Descheneaux (Ecurise CSL) was looking to buy a young horse like this, so that's kind of why I got a bit more involved and part of the deal."

Friday's victory was the third in six starts for Dws Point Man and vaults his earnings from \$13,746 to \$63,946. A \$2 win ticket on the Moreau student returned \$10.10.

The fourth Gold leg for 2-year-old colt and gelding trotters will take place on Sept. 4 at Flamboro Downs.

Bond made her first career stake victory look easy Friday (Aug. 12) at Hollywood Casino at The Meadows, jogging to a 3-1/2-length triumph in a \$73,634 Pennsylvania Sires Stake test for 2-year-old trotting fillies. **Uno Mas Blue Chip** took the other division in the event, known as the Delmonica Hanover, for freshman filly trotters.

Bond entered the Delmonica Hanover off a pair of strong secondplace finishes in the Kindergarten series at the Meadowlands. She went one better than that Friday, seating the previously unbeaten Portulaca for trainer/driver Ake Svanstedt. Portulaca tried to close, but Bond was neither shaken nor stirred, keeping Portulaca second in the 1:55.3 mile. Lady Lira completed the ticket.

"She's raced well every time," said Svanstedt of the physically impressive daughter of Southwind Frank—Boccone Dolce. "She's shown a lot of fight so far. She wants to win."

Ake Svanstedt Inc. LLC, Little E LLC and L Berg Inc. campaign Bond, who is paid into the Lexington Grand Circuit stakes and the Breeders Crown.

Uno Mas Blue Chip took an Arden Downs Grand Circuit split at The Meadows in her most recent outing, giving winning trainer Clifton Green a reasonably high level of confidence for the Delmonica Hanover.

"As long as she keeps her head together, I think she'll learn to go," Green said. "She knows to pass in the stretch. Today she seemed to be more level headed than she's ever been — especially behind the gate. She really improved today."

The daughter of International Moni—Make It Blue Chip, a \$35,000 yearling purchase, followed cover beautifully for Hunter Myers, defeating Cando Volo by 1-1/4 lengths in 1:57.1, with the first-over Wild Jiggy S third. Ashley Burslem and Steven Mullen own Uno Mas Blue Chip.

STALLION SERIES — 2-YEAR-OLD FILLY TROT

Gina's On Fire had been getting mostly covered trips, but when trainer/driver Todd Schadel got her to the point early in Friday's sub-feature, she apparently liked the view. The daughter of Cantab Hall—Shes On Fire blew the field away by 8-3/4 lengths in a careerbest 1:56.3. Wind N Water and Atovera rounded out the ticket.

Schadel, who owns the youngster with Christine Schadel, said the blowout won't persuade him to change the filly's style.

"She'd have been way better sitting in a hole," he said. "Don't get me wrong, I'm not saying she didn't race well. But she's better from a hole."

Elsewhere on the card, the Dave Palone Express rolled on. With five wins Friday, Palone has collected 22 victories over the past five cards.



The third leg of the Buckeye Stallion Series for sophomore colt trotters was on display at Eldorado Scioto Downs Friday (Aug. 13) and **Hustlenomics** did not disappoint as he rolled to his third straight victory in the series.

Hustlenomics and Trevor Smith grabbed the lead heading to the half mile mark and fought off a late challenge from Rose Run Xander to win by a neck. Trained by Todd Luther, Hustlenomics tripped the wire in 1:56.2. It was the eighth win of the year in 14 starts for the son of Full Count who raised his earnings this year to \$80,050 and now has earned \$105,496 in his lifetime. Hustlenomics is owned by Black Magic Racing.

In the first and fastest of the four \$17,500 divisions, **Peterbilt** won for the first time in the Buckeye Stallion Series. Sitting fourth around the final turn, Chris Page looked to fire down the passing lane but swung to the middle of the stretch to nip the favorite, Slim Jimmy, at the wire by a ¼ of a length. The 1:55.3 mile was the fastest of the night in the Buckeye Stallion Series. The win was the third of the year in ten starts for the Fred Morgan Jr. trainee who has now earned \$34,415 for owner John Holman.

In the second division, **Admire** with Dan Noble made his move just past the half-mile mark and charged to the lead and pulled away to win by five lengths in 1:57.1. It was the first race in Ohio for the son of Creatine whose first three wins of the year were in Kentucky. Bob Stewart trains and co-owns Admire with Lynda Stewart. Admire has earned \$23,510 this year.

In the final division of the night, **Floyd Of Rosedale** and Kayne Kaufman grabbed the lead for good just past the half mile mark and held on down the stretch to win by a head in 1:57.4. It was the fourth win in 13 starts for the gelded son of Southwind Spirit. Owned by the Second Chance Stable and trained by Charlie Myrick, Floyd Of Rosedale has earned \$34,335 this year.

Buckeye Stallion Series action resumes Tuesday (Aug. 16) at Eldorado Scioto Downs with four divisions of 2-year-old filly trotters. First race post time is 3:15 p.m.
