Catch The Fire sizzles to exhilarating finish in Dan Patch

Scott Zeron split through horses and won a five-horse finish by a neck in the \$325,000 event held Friday night at Harrah's Hoosier Park.

The Dan Patch Stakes has served as the backdrop for many memorable races over the last 27 years, with some of the sport's top free-for-allers circling Harrah's Hoosier Park's seven-eighths-mile oval. Friday's (Aug. 13) 28th renewal of the track's signature event may have provided the most exciting finish to date. Favored Catch The Fire and driver Scott Zeron split horses deep in the stretch to push a neck in front in the \$325,000 event, presented by Brittany Farms, prevailing in a fantastic five-horse finish in a time of 1:48.1.

"I had enough room, it was just a matter of if any driver left or right had chosen to drift. It would have gotten real tight," Zeron said of the late surge to the wire. "I had room when I went up there and I never stopped pushing him through it. I didn't have to check him."

Catch The Fire has been "en fuego" of late for Greg Luther's Black Magic Racing, LLC and CT Stables, LLC. Trained by Luther's brother, Todd, the 4-year-old son of Captaintreacherous – Dream Outloud is riding an incredible streak dating back to late June, registering five wins in six starts, four of them by a neck. Entering the Dan Patch after scoring a lifetime best 1:47.2 in the \$157,100 Sam McKee Memorial at the Meadowlands, the stallion's latest narrow victory minted him as the sport's newest millionaire.

"In all honesty, he's supposed to lose a lot of those races. But he just fights so hard; he just refuses to lose," said Greg Luther, hoarse from cheering Catch The Fire through the stretch. "They

were five across the track tonight, amazing horses out there. The best in the business. To see him keep driving and do what it takes, it was phenomenal. It's very exciting."

Greg has been in acquisition mode over the past year, notably undertaking a "million-dollar experiment" that saw him invest in

quality yearlings last fall in hopes of developing Grand Circuit-caliber racing talent. He expanded the experiment to include proven horses that can race and win now. The owner bought into the 2020 Adios champion over the winter, and the stallion has split duties as a stud and racehorse, covering 85 mares during the breeding season at Sugar Valley Farm. He is again planning to invest more, this time in breeding stock to support the stallion.

"Tonight I'm on a high. You usually don't make a lot of money with 2-year-olds. You hope they come back as a 3-year-old. So it's a three-to-four year plan," he said. "We got very lucky being at the right place at the right time to get a hold of this stallion. He's just been phenomenal. His heart; he's unbelievable. Trust me, my experiment just went up another million dollars because I'm buying a lot of broodmares to breed to this guy."

At the end of the 2020 campaign, Catch The Fire boasted earnings a few thousand short of \$700,000 and a mark of 1:49.1. With his Dan Patch victory, he has banked just over \$343,000 this season and is now the third richest horse sired by Captaintreacherous, trailing only Captain Crunch and mare Lyons Sentinel. With his ever-growing credentials, could 2021

be Catch The Fire's swansong before moving to full-time stallion duties? Todd Luther is focused on appreciating the opportunity he has this season.

"People wait a lifetime for a horse like this and I've got three of them in the barn, I think. It's an unbelievable ride, that's for sure," he said of conditioning Catch The Fire, Chief Mate and Captain Kirk. "I leave that up to Greg and Charlie (Taylor of CT Stables). While he's racing, I'm going to enjoy every minute of it."

The connections had plenty to enjoy Friday night, even if the victory was another nail-biter. Starting from post position four,

Catch The Fire was in the mix early for Zeron as Cattlewash and David Miller fired from his outside along with Workin Ona Mystery. After settling into fourth through a :25.3 opening panel, Zeron brushed to the lead.

"I wanted to position him as close as I could to the front and just stay in there. I didn't think I'd have to leave as hard as he could, get away fourth with a very good horse behind my back in Yannick (This Is The Plan)," Zeron said of the strategy. "I had a decision to make when I landed there. Do I wait and come first up? It just seems like the worst move you can make here at

Hoosier. I made the decision to power move to the front over top of Cattlewash, not knowing how fast we'd have to do it. When I saw the teletimer come up (:54.1), it was okay. I knew who was coming, the train behind me. It was an easy choice to let Yannick go and put Backsteet Shadow in a bad spot."

In the last turn, This Is The Plan led the field with Backstreet Shadow and Trace Tetrick first-up and challenging. Little Rocket Man, with John DeLong in the bike, sat second over ready to launch as Zeron and Catch The Fire waited along the pylons in the pocket. Once again, Zeron had a choice to make; hold until the passing lane and slip to the inside or look for room between horses.

"I don't drive here regularly, so I don't know how great that passing lane is, because it's way up there down the stretch. When I had a little seam to go to the right, as long as I didn't get pinched, I'd definitely have full clearance for my race bike," he said. "By the same token, this horse just loves to race other horses. To make him split through them, he would go through them a lot quicker than he would if I pulled him down to the rail to go inside of one. It worked out."

Finding the seam between This Is The Plan and Backstreet Shadow, Zeron and Catch The Fire seized the opportunity, shooting the gap and collecting their third straight triumph as a team. Indiana Sires Stakes champion and local entry Tellmeaboutit could see the field racing out of the final turn. The Alvin Miller trainee, sent off at odds of 69-1, stormed down the center of the track for Mike Oosting, reeling in the field with a :25.2 last quarter and lunging in the final strides to nearly steal the show with a close second. Backstreet Shadow and Little Rocket Man, a Hoosier Park fan favorite, each fought gamely in the lane to finish third and fourth, respectively, while This Is The Plan was fifth, three parts of a length back. Catch The Fire returned \$4.40 - \$3.40 - \$2.80 and Tellmeaboutit paid \$35.00 - \$9.60 while triggering a \$205.20 exacta. The trifecta paid \$455.30.

"That was a genius move. Once they settled he made a smart move to the front. I saw a horse coming hard and I said we're going to be pushed the whole way, but it turned out it was This Is The Plan. That's a good helmet to follow," Greg Luther said of watching the race unfold from the apron. "So we got a really good two-hole trip behind him, kind of like in the Sam McKee. Scotty can drive this horse any time he wants because

he's putting him in the right spots, for sure."

Catch The Fire's triumph is only the second time in 28 editions that victory was determined by a neck. Mister Big prevailed over Winbak Speed in the 2009 running, narrowly edging ahead in a two-horse photo. For an event that attracts some of the top speed horses annually, Catch The Fire becomes the 15th 4-year-old to claim a Dan Patch win. He is also the 13th favorite to reach the winner's circle. The victory is the first for all connections. In three previous attempts, Zeron's best finish came in 2016 steering Shamballa to third place, dead-heating with All Bets Off.

"It's a great race. You get the best of the best. From anyone watching, even sitting in the race bike, it was a pretty exhilarating race. You beat the best aged pacers, it's a great feeling," Zeron said of his breakthrough win.


Greg said the plan is to give the stallion a well-deserved week off. He hopes Catch The Fire will receive an invite to the #Senditin Stakes at Scioto Downs, their home track. A ship north of the border for the Canadian Pacing Derby is also on the slate.

"It's an amazing ride," he said, clutching the Dan Patch trophy and beaming with pride. "To have the family involved, it's been an absolutely amazing ride for all of us."

A conversation with the amazing Wanda Polisseni

The proprietor of Purple Haze Stable and the Purple Haze Standardbred Adoption program loves her horses beyond measure.

Last week was the first time I've had the privilege of having any sort of extended conversation with Wanda Polisseni. What an amazing lady!

She is best known in the harness racing fraternity as the proprietor of Purple Haze Stable and its equine charitable offshoot Purple Haze Standardbred Adoption program.

As much as she loves her horses and very few among us love them as much, she loves her family even more. She and her late husband Gene had four children and now have five grandchildren aged 22 through 27.

No one, especially a parent, should go through as much heartbreak as has befallen Wanda. She lost her daughter Kimberly at the age of 18 due to a drunk driver. Her husband Gene, one of the founders of the payroll service giant Paychex, passed after 40 years of marriage and just this year her son, noted artist and philanthropist Greg Polisseni, left us at the young age of 50.


"How are you able to overcome such tragedy?" I asked her. "You don't," she said. "You try to live with it. I miss them all

enormously and will never get over their loss."

Our conversation turned to one of the great loves of her life — horses.

How did you get involved with horses?

"We had a 540 acre farm. Our next door neighbors raced horses at Batavia Downs and periodically boarded their horses with us. I watched them and fell in love with them. I said to myself that one day I was going to own and race some myself. I never realized how many that would possibly involve. Initially, I bought six horses through Clint Galbraith. That didn't work out too well. Subsequently, I had some other trainers until I met Trond Smedshammer with whom I still have all my standardbreds. I actually also owned some thoroughbreds with Trond as a partner."

You mentioned the thoroughbreds, Wanda. Do you still own and race them?

"Indeed I do. Each year I have about 100 horses in training. There are pretty much evenly divided between standardbreds and thoroughbreds."

Which do you prefer?

"I love them both. But they are quite different. We race the trotters and pacers much more often than we do the runners. They both have their plusses. I love the pageantry and beauty of the thoroughbred business. I hate that they can be so fragile. There is very little that can be more heart breaking than seeing a horse that one owns, or actually any horse that anyone owns, break down. Unfortunately, you see it far more often with the thoroughbreds than you do with the trotters and pacers."

Is there anything you advise your trainers about?


"I have one golden rule. No horse of mine is to be raced that is lame or sick. I feel responsible for them once I own them. Good or bad, I have a great responsibility to them. If they reach the point where they cannot race any longer, it becomes my responsibility to make sure that they live out their lives in relative comfort. Of course, I realize that some horses reach a stage where they are in constant pain for which there is no end in sight. In that case I will never allow then to go to the Amish where they will endure a difficult life or to be sold for meat. In cases such as that I believe they should be euthanized."

Let's speak about Trond Smedshammer and your relationship with him.

"I believe we are two kindred spirits. We think alike and have the same philosophy about our horses. We only want to race them when they are fit and competitive. I speak with him just about every day. It would have been very difficult to get through the loss of Greg if I didn't have Trond to fall back upon."

Do you make any of the decisions regarding the purchases of your horses?

"I suppose that I ultimately do in writing the checks. But I leave almost all of it up to those whose hands the horses are going to be in. They are the professionals. I shouldn't be owning horses if I didn't have complete trust in who will be training them."



How do you go about determine how much you are going to spend?

"I don't have partners and I don't want to have partners. So my expenditures are somewhat limited by going against the partnership groups that are so prevalent in buying yearlings today. They can easily afford to pay large amounts because the risk is spread among several people."

You say you don't want partners. Why?

"Because partnerships beget bickering and second guessing. That's not who I am and I don't want any part of it. When I give my horses to someone, it's because I respect them and their professionalism."

How many horses do you have going into the year?

"I usually start with around 100, fairly equally divided between the two breeds. Most of them are yearlings. It's somewhat ironic that I don't strongly believe in racing 2-year-olds — especially not racing them hard. But I realize that it's an absolute economic necessity. In a perfect world, they would be saved until they are most physically mature, but the economic structure of the business would likely collapse without them."

Do you have any geographical preference with the horses you select?

"I live in New York. I believe in supporting my home state which still has an excellent program, so most of my purchases are New York breds. On the other hand, I also love racing on the Grand Circuit so I buy a number of yearlings from other states."

I notice that most of your horses are trotters. Do you prefer them to pacers?

"Not really. I buy mostly trotters because that's what Trond prefers and excels at. I believe that he is one of the world's great horsemen. Sometimes I don't believe he gets the respect he deserves. He makes all the decisions — even those where he chooses to get someone else to drive. I'd be perfectly satisfied to have him drive all the time. However, he thinks that sometimes in the bigger races, he could be handicapped by not getting the breaks that others may get. In any event I am perfectly satisfied with any decision he makes."

It's somewhat unusual in this business in that everyone I know that knows you speaks well of you. I have never heard a bad word uttered about you and the way you do business. "It's actually quite simple. Most people are nice. I treat people as I would hope to be treated."

How do you feel about winning? That's the name of the game isn't it?

"Of course I enjoy winning, but that isn't all there is to it. As long as the race goes off well and all that have competed in it return healthy is what is most important to me."

What possessed you at the age of 80 to venture into the Purple Haze Standardbred Adoption Program?

"Simply put, I want to save every horse that I can. I have the means to do it, so I decided to. I don't expect accolades. I try to treat everybody in the same manner that I would like to be treated."

Milligan's School upsets at Åby

The \$345,000 Åby Stora Pris over 1.95 miles closed the V75 race card at Åby racetrack on Saturday afternoon (Aug. 14) and an upset winner played with the opponents and overcame post 10.

Driver Ulf Eriksson made a quick move from post 10 when the car left the 12 horses strong field as he sent Stefan Melander-trained **Milligan's School** (Yankee Glide) between horses and made first choice Who's Who three wide as the first turn approached. Who's Who didn't manage to keep his gait at that point and he disappeared after going off stride.

Ulf Eriksson's move was a winning tactic since Milligan's School could hit the lead when the field entered the back stretch for the first time and when the duo came to the lead, not much happened in the 3,140 meters long race.

Four-year-old Bengurion Jet was left first over and driver Alessandro Gocciadoro was clearly not satisfied with that position, the problem was that none of the opponents were interested in relieving him, whereupon the pace could be set at the level Ulf Eriksson wanted with leader Milligan's School.

(717) 637-8931 fax: (717) 637-6766 theblackbook.com French trotters Ce Bello Romain and Carat Williams tried their attacks three wide with a lap to go and Eriksson started to warm up the turbo in Milligan's School at the same moment, so trotters from positions far back in the field were more or less without chance to challenge for the medals.

Milligan's School held Zarenne Fas and Mindyourvalue W.F. in safe distance over the stretch and Stefan Melander's trotter came home in a world record mile rate of 1:55.4 over 1.95 miles.

Eight-year-old Milligan's School came from Julie Miller's stable to Sweden during the winter of 2016-17 and has been very successful in Melander's barn. Milligan's School has earned \$1,910,842 and has collected 30 wins in 112 starts.



Hail to Ake!

Last Saturday's Hambletonian was a total celebration of Swedish horsemanship. For some unknown reason, at least unknown to this kid, Ake Svansteadt has received only a tiny fraction of the praise he deserves for his Hambletonian accomplishments. Not only did he train and drive the decisive winner, Captain Corey, but he also trained both the colts that finished third and fourth in our most important harness race.


In a day and time when trainers only train and drivers only drive, and plumbers only plumb and lawyers only lie, etc., Svanstedt showed the world he was a master of both practices. My memory may not be infallible, but I'm pretty sure no trainer before, in all the years the Hambletonian has been raced, ever trained three of the first four finishers, including the winner.

As an aside, Svanstedt's chief second trainer is his wife, Sarah. She's also a talented driver, and in fact she drove Captain Corey in his first baby race last year as a 2-year-old; and drove him well, finishing a good, unhurried second, giving him the education he needed to become the racing machine he is today.

As a personal note, I like to tease Ake that he needs to smile more when his picture is being taken. I'm happy to say he didn't need any encouragement in the smiling department last Saturday. And what he did last Saturday will give him a reason to smile for the rest of his life.

Captain Corey's win was also a triumph for another Swedish horseman Robert Lindstrom. Lindstrom fastened onto Captain Corey at his first, informed glance. The story of how he managed to come up, in the moment, with the \$150,000 it took to buy him, is a living testament to Lindstrom's self-confidence and powers of persuasion (full story here). By the time he had found the money to make the winning bid, he must have approached every horse loving Swede within a hundred miles of the Fasig-Tipton Sales Pavilion.

Here, please forgive this kid for relating his own Captain Corey caper, and its philosophical implications.



Last year, after Captain Corey had won his first three starts for money, I suggested to a good friend, a fellow breeder, that he explore the possibility of buying an interest, say 25 per cent, of the colt. At the time I was also heeling for a possible job as an advisor at the same farm, and perhaps this suggestion would clinch the deal.

Alas, it had the exact opposite effect. There was no interest whatever in investing good money in a 2-year-old who had only made three starts. Let him keep winning this year and next, and then we'll be willing to talk turkey. But now, with only three starts in a sire stakes program, fugetaboutit.

For me, however, those three starts were enough to convince me that the colt had great sire potential. As you've heard too many times before, I share with the great Italian thoroughbred breeder, Federico Tesio, that 2-year-old brilliance on the racetrack is the best single indicator of future success as a sire. Not that it's infallible, by any means, but it's still the best we've got to go by.


There was something else, also, that made Captain Corey alluring. He's by the pacing bred Goo Goo Ga Ga, out of a mare by Angus Hall, making him an outcross sire for all the mares sired by the popular trotting sires of today. Which will give him a definite edge up when he enters the stud. And again, you can't make a bad sire with good mares, just as you can't stop a good sire with bad mares. But from a business standpoint, Captain Corey will sure make a harvest in his first four years in the stud.

Now for the philosophical part. For this kid, the horse business has always meant betting big on the unusual, or the otherwise unrecognized. There were always bargains to be had at public sales when a well-bred barren mare was offered. You just did a little research, determined that there was nothing wrong with her other than just deciding to take a year off, and you had a good mare that more than earned back her purchase price with her first foal.

Garland Lobell was just killing time in Quebec while the wonderful Saccomani brothers were just waiting for a breeder from the States to realize they owned a world class sire. Striking Sahbra, likewise, was cooling his heels in Ohio while he waited for someone to realize he was a great sire, and act on it.

The same rationale applied to going back to darkest Quebec and grabbing up two breed-changing mares in Amour Angus and Canne Angus. It also meant buying half of Dewey after he'd made two starts for money at 2. As the world, or at least our little part of it, now knows, Dewey didn't make it as a sire, but he still made a lot of money for us.

The list goes on a little longer, but the point has already been made. One can be conservative in the horse biz if they've got the money to pay top dollar for proven commodities. But for the rest of us, the way to success lies in the paths less taken,



and a Yiddishe Kop can also be helpful.

On a different note, looking back to 1971, Rum Customer was ready to be retired to the stud after a successful racing career. Billy Haughton and Lloyd Lloyds (yes, that's his real name) his trainer and owner, respectively, gave him to me to syndicate. He was a popular horse, but the key selling point was that he had won a million dollars, not nearly so easy then as it became later.

Actually, at the time I syndicated him, he hadn't won a million dollars, but Roosevelt Raceway was going to take care of that little detail by putting on a "Farewell Pace" with a purse of \$25,000.

It was late fall by then. Billy had long since gone to Florida with his big stable of babies to get started, and Del Insko was down to drive the horse in his final start. All Insko needed to do was finish fifth and it would be mission accomplished. And at the time Del was the leading drive on the Yonkers-Roosevelt circuit. Easy Peasy, no?

Except that Insko decided to let the horse go out in a blaze of glory, got him parked the whole mile, and finished sixth. And by now he was fully syndicated as a million-dollar winner.

Desperately I looked for a racetrack that was still open in December. There was only one in those early days, Aurora Downs, in Aurora, IL. Aurora Downs was a tiny harness track whose license allowed it only to race when no other track, harness or thoroughbred, was racing in the state of Illinois.

So, Aurora Downs it had to be, and fortunately the racing secretary then was a somewhat friend of mine. I told him of my plight, and he agreed to put on a FFA pace with a \$7,500 purse. This was more money than any of the turtles racing at Aurora had ever gone for in their lives, so the race filled. Insko was press-ganged to fly out to Aurora to drive Rum Customer, and to make sure he got there on time, I went with him.

Off they went in the biggest purse race Aurora would ever put on, and under a heavy drive, Rum Customer stumbled home first in 2:07. Finally, mission really accomplished.

But this was a big deal for the management of this misbegotten track, and there was a ceremony in the winner's circle. In a fitting gesture for the moment, the track had come up with a wreath of flowers, and it was hung around our horse's neck. Unfortunately, at that point a chill wind that Chicago was famous for, blew in. It completely blew off everything on the floral wreath, leaving Rum Customer standing there with only the metal frame still around his neck. And me, standing next to him, wondering why I hadn't gone to law school when I had the chance.







Amanda Beaver – Chris Beaver Stable

There are two sayings in life that Amanda Beaver can relate to: "If things are meant to be, they will" and "Being in the right place at the right time." She should add: "She had an angel watching over her." For by the grace of God she is here to tell her story.

"I was born in Ashland, Ohio. My family was not involved in harness racing, but I always wanted to work with these incredible animals so when I was younger I went to different stables looking to see if anyone needed help. I got a job working at a breeding farm — Success Acres — and immediately knew I wanted to make it my career.

"After working at the farm I got a job for trainer Ron Steck while his wife was on maternity leave and he needed help. After his wife returned to work, Ron suggested I go work for a trainer named Chris Beaver. Unbeknownst to me at that time, my new boss would eventually become my future husband.

"I worked for Chris on and off for 10 years. During that time Chris and I were both married, but years later when our marriages dissolved, we started dating each other, and as they say, the rest is history."

And what an impact the husband and wife team has made in the sport.

"In the beginning Chris wanted to be a veterinarian, but right before starting vet school, he purchased his first yearling, a filly named RAGING SAMANTHA for \$9,500 and hit the lottery. After earning almost \$500,000 he ended up selling her overseas for a half-million dollars," Amanda said.

Unlike his wife, Chris grew up in the business. His father was a horse trainer and also owned a meat packing plant. Because his parents told him he couldn't make a living in training horses, he opted to be a veterinarian. After selling Raging Samantha, Chris decided to go all in.

It was certainly the right decision for the young man. Decades

later, the Beaver Stable is one of - if not *the* best - harness racing stables based in Ohio.

"When we first got together Chris had 12 horses, but after working together that number grew to 40. So, I'd like to think I had something to do with that," Amanda said.

Today, there are 55 horses in the Beaver Stable.

In the beginning, Amanda helped her husband run the Ohio farm while Chris would race in Canada. That continued until six years ago when Amanda was hit by a semi-truck.

Unfortunately, that turn of events would put an end to what Amanda loves to do the most — train — but today she is in charge of breeding and foaling the horses. It is really a miracle given the impact of the semi was quite serious.

Presently, the Beavers own 15 broodmares, but board several out until they can purchase more land.

Throughout the years, the Beavers have had tremendous success with numerous horses, such as IL SOGNO DREAM.

"I raced Il Songo Dream a lot myself — from warming him up to paddocking and shipping. Il Songo Dream liked to listen to Bob Marley before he raced. Guess he liked reggae music," Amanda said.

"Il Songo had a personality that many people didn't like, but he was always very sweet to me. I still love and miss him, but know he's living a good life standing stud in Canada today."

Raging Samantha and Il Songo Dream are just two of the many superstars who would come out of the Beaver Stable.

"CUSTOM CANTAB is one of the best horses we have ever trained She made over a million dollars during her 4-year-old career campaign and was race timed in 1:49 and change at The Meadowlands — coming within a nose of winning the Hambletonian Maturity (she was set back for interference). When she was at her best she raced against Atlanta and Manchego, finishing within one or two lengths behind them.

"And of course there's TRIUMPHANT CAVIAR who set a world record at 3 in Delaware and earned \$796,794."

With such success I asked Amada what they look for when buying a yearling.

"Chris and I look at horses differently. He's a bloodline guy and I'm a confirmation girl and can see imperfections quickly. I'm also good at watching the videos and the horses' gait. My husband also taught me to look for what 'imperfections' he will work with."

Although they train both trotters and pacers, Chris prefers the natural gaited athletes and has become known as a "trotting" guy.

"We train about 95 per cent trotters. Chris says he likes the trotters because he feels like he gains an advantage by using his mind to figure them out. They are a challenge and he likes taking on challenges, and it has all been good because in the

end it is what he's better at."

When not at the farm in Ohio, the Beavers train and break yearlings at Spring Garden Ranch in Florida during the winter.

Together they have five children. The two youngest girls help their parents in the summertime as stall cleaners and grooms.

Working with your husband day in and day out can be quite nerve-wracking, but it's not that way for Amanda.

"Anyone that knows my husband can get along with him. I'm really lucky to have him, for he is the most patient, kind, and honest man I've ever met.

"He works so hard. During the stake season he literally puts in 20 hours a day; and at times he's in two to three states in a 24 hour period."

As far as the future in harness racing, they try to stay positive. Their wish and goal is to get to the point where they can feel content with what they have accomplished.

I'm sure you will agree with me that the Beavers have nothing to worry about.





Charlie May dominates \$300,000 Carl Milstein Memorial at MGM Northfield Park

Pacer posted the third world record of the night at the track — all by Ohio-sired horses.

Ohio-sired **Charlie May** crossed the wire an impressive winner in Saturday's (Aug. 14) \$300,000 Carl Milstein Memorial, a Grand Circuit event at MGM Northfield Park against some of the best sophomore pacers in North America.

He and driver Brett Miller went to the gate on the heels of being disqualified after winning the \$700,000 Meadowlands Pace just four weeks prior.

Charlie May started from post seven and sat fifth through the opening :26 quarter.

"We got a little bit lucky in the first turn to find a seat," said Miller.

Charlie May (Brett Miller) won Saturday's \$300,000 Carl Milstein Memorial at MGM Northfield Park in 1:48.4.

Charlie May was in the flow, third over, but still in fifth position at the :53.2 half-mile mark. Miller called upon Charlie May in the third quarter, tipping three-wide and accelerating at an amazing speed, arriving in the lead at the three-quarter pole in 1:20.4. He continued to pull away from the others, winning by 4-3/4 lengths in 1:48.4. The clocking was a track and world record for sophomore gelded pacers.

"Once he (Charlie May) made the front he kind of let up," explained Miller. "He would have gone faster if he had someone to pass."

Charlie May (McArdle—Stipple Hanover) is owned by Don Tiger of Canonsburg, PA. Steve Carter trains him at his farm track in Londonderry, OH.

"It is very sweet to win this race here in Ohio," said Carter. "This horse shows up every week and always does his work."

Saturday's victory is the 12th score for Charlie May. The win pushes his earnings to \$728,477.

Following in succession after Charlie May were: Mysweetboymax, Water Sports Teen, Rockin On Venus, Bettor Sun, Chase H Hanover, Heart Of Chewbacca, Bayfield Beach and Alilthundadownunda.

Charlie May returned \$4.60 to win.

The race was in honor of Carl Milstein, who owned and operated Northfield Park from 1984 until his death in 1999. It is the richest invitational event in harness racing for pacers.

The impressive clocking was the third world record scored on the night. The two races prior to the main event, **Weslynn Quest** and **Ocean Rock** captured the \$100,000 Tom Aldrich President's Trot and \$100,000 Myron Charna President's Pace, respectively. The races are for veteran Ohio-sired horses, by invitation only.

Weslynn Quest won the Aldrich by leading gate-to-wire from the rail, winning by ¾-length in 1:50.4. The speedy clocking is the fastest mile in history trotted on a half-mile track. Joe Bongiorno drove the five-year-old mare for trainer Per Englom.

Ocean Rock, winner of the Charna, set his second world record on the Flying Turns. Saturday's 1:48.1 clocking is the fastest mile ever paced by a four-year old gelding on a half-mile track. In 2019 he set a world record for freshman gelded pacers at Northfield in 1:51.1. Dan Noble drove the pacer for his wife Christi Noble, the horse's trainer.

What's in a name? Not enough in our case - Part 2

Last week, your humble scribe suggested that purposely naming our horses after businesses could and should be of possible value to the sport (full story here).

Let us press this concept forward, perhaps towards absurdity. Renaming my lone broodmare has a minimal chance of helping grow the sport. Renaming a dozen horses increases the chances of recruitment, and renaming a hundred or a thousand could help a great deal. Injecting a bit of friendly competition often acts as motivation.

How? Let's get absurd.

Fred Taylor owns the *Fairwinds Standardbred Breeding Farm*. Each year, his band of broodmares gives birth to babies that require names. In 2022, he decides to name his young horses after businesses in Medina, OH. Medina is a delightful town, large enough to have several companies, yet small enough to have a sense of community. Fred settles on a group of local businesses for an adventure/experiment.

After he selects a dozen businesses to invite to participate, his office manager, Renee, is tasked with arranging a Zoom meeting for the potential participants.

2 p.m. - Wednesday, Aug. 12, 2021

Fred begins, "Hello, thanks for logging in for this unusual meeting. Can the six of you see me? Hear me?"

A chorus of yeses.

He continues, "This will only take about 10 minutes. According to Facebook, it is good to begin a zoom meeting with an introduction and an open-ended question to act as an icebreaker. Would you each introduce yourself with your first name, the name of your company or business, and where or when you would set your time machine for a day? Let me go first.



"I'm Fred, from **Fairwinds Farm**. We raise trotting horses. My time machine would be the day the founding fathers ratified the Constitution. How about we start in the upper right corner of our screens."

"I guess that means me. Okay, I'm Roger, Medina County **Gazette.** Of course, we are a newspaper. I want to step on the moon with Neil Armstrong."

"And I am Charlene, **Tangerine Parlour,** Beauty Shoppe. I want to be front row in the 1960s when The Beatles were performing in a London Club."

"Mickey, **Vidika.** My company is into cement. I would probably want to watch over Leonardo DaVinci's shoulder as he sketched inventions."

"Rhonda, **JACOR**, human resources. No doubt about it, a café table in Paris in the 1920s with a bottle of wine, holding one of those long cigarette holders."

"Dennis, **Chippewa Stone**, we do projects like kitchen counters. I'd like to see the Egyptians laying the final few rows of the Great Pyramid."

"Kevin, **Al Root**, candle company. I was going to say the Chicago Fair of 1900, but I'm changing and going with Dennis to the Pyramid."

Fred, "Very nice. Thanks, everyone. I invited six more business owners for another meeting tomorrow. Six at a time seem more comfortable. Let me begin and try to clear up this craziness. I grew up in Medina, and the city has a warm spot in my heart. These days I am in central Ohio. As I mentioned, I raise and sell trotting horses. My customers buy these beautiful trotting horses to race at racetracks."

"Please relax. I am not asking you to purchase or invest a penny. I want nothing from any of you. On the contrary, you could say I am offering a little entertainment and perhaps free publicity. The only thing you need to do is give me written permission to use the name of your company name on one of the foals born on my farm this spring.

"After that, you wait as the horse grows tall and strong and hopefully races, a process that will last until the summer of 2024. At that time, in July of 2024, a contest between these business-named horses will begin."

Mickey, the cement man, asked, "What sort of contest?"

"When these horses are 2 years old, most of them will begin racing and attempt to earn money. The contest will be to see which of these horses earn the most money on the racetrack. The business-named horse with the most earnings will be declared the winner of the, so far unnamed contest."

Dennis, the stone man, asked, "What will we win?"

"Bragging rights, a framed photograph, and a check for \$1,000 donated to a local charity of your choice. Maybe a visit from the horse. Who knows? Much is to be determined."

Roger, the publisher of the Gazette, spoke, "Is that why you included a newspaper?"

"Yes, you were the first business on my list. And among the other businesses are an advertising firm and a radio station. They may want to join us."

Charlene, the beautician, asked, "Is there any liability, any cost?"

"None. Think of your horses as equine billboards racing around with your company or business name. Will this help you business-wise? Maybe not, but there is no downside."

Rhonda, from human resources, says, "You are talking about a horse that will not race for two years. Anything can happen in two years. We might not be in business, or there might be new ownership, and I know a little bit about harness racing, enough to know the new owner can change the name."

"All valid points. Here's the thing, who knows where this naming thing will go. This little project could be a total dud, or it could become trendy. Your workers could have fun with the project. Your customers could enjoy the project. Everything right now is on the table. I'm just laying the groundwork. My only ask is permission to use your name."

Dennis asked, "If you use my company name, **Chippewa Stone**, how do you decide which of your horses get which name?"


"I don't have any reason. Right now, the babies are unnamed. They are roaming by mom's side in the field. Who gets what name is completely random."

Charlene, "Oh, oh, I have an idea. Why don't you invite us to your farm, so we can look at the babies and sort of pick out the one we want? **Tangerine Parlour** would need to be a girl."

Fred smiled, "That would be fine, we enjoy having visitors, and it is only an hour and twenty-minute drive."

Several voices at once were enthusiastically asking additional questions. The adventure has begun.







Global Pandemic equals PASS record; all five break in other split

Global Pandemic turned back his rival, Keg Stand, and matched the stake record of 1:54.4 in his \$78,160 Pennsylvania Sires Stake (PASS) test on Friday (Aug. 13) at The Meadows.

The event for 2-year-old colt and gelding trotters, known as the Florida Pro, was contested over two divisions, and the other split may have made PASS history of sorts. All five starters broke stride in the final quarter, and the horse who jumped it off first, **Khal Drogo**, rallied to finish second and was awarded the victory.

Keg Stand, who defeated Global Pandemic in a July 14 PASS at The Meadows, was sent off the 1-5 favorite, and when he bore down on Global Pandemic in the lane, he figured to go on by. But the son of Cantab Hall-Nicole's Promise, perhaps a stronger colt than he was a month ago, dug in and held off Keg Stand by 1/2 length, with Kosher Mahoney third.

"He's a big colt, and it's taken him a little time," said winning driver Yannick Gingras. "Believe me, he's been good the whole time, but he was definitely better today."

The time equaled the mark held jointly by Sutton and Real Cool Sam. Ron Burke trains Global Pandemic, who lifted his career bankroll north of \$125,000, for Burke Racing Stable, Hatfield Stables and Weaver Bruscemi LLC.

In the other split, Khal Drogo began the festivities when, with a seemingly unassailable lead, he jumped it off into the final turn. That was the signal for Nice Guy Eddie (Ake Svanstedt) to stick 'em in. In doing so, he got into Troycen (Dexter Dunn), who also broke.

That sequence left only Ginger Tree Brad (Aaron Merriman) and Fiftyfour K (Jim Pantaleano) still in apparent contention. Ginger Tree Brad broke once passed, and Fiftyfour K had only to stay flat to win. But about 50 yards short of the wire, he broke and could not regain his gait, despite Pantaleano's best efforts.

Fiftyfour K crossed the wire 2-3/4 lengths ahead of Khal Drogo but was disqualified for violation of the breaking rule and, following a lengthy review, placed back to third. When Nice Guy Eddie was elevated to second, then placed back to last, Fiftyfour K was promoted to second. Ginger Tree Brad was fourth-placed-third. The judges awarded Khal Drogo the winning time of 1:58.4.

Winning driver David Miller said he has driven in break-fests where all horses went off stride but never in one featuring trotters of sires stake-caliber.

"That was bizarre, wasn't it?" Miller said. "I honestly thought my horse could win today. I was a little but surprised that he ran. He's pretty good gaited, but he got a little too crooked in the last turn."

It wasn't exactly a by-the-book victory, but it allowed Khal Drogo, a son of Andover Hall—Mariah Dancer, to extend his winning streak to three for trainer Brett Ecker and owner Silver Bullet Stable.

Burke, who trains Fiftyfour K for Here's To Us Stable, said he has appealed the disqualification to the PA Horse Racing Commission, arguing that the horse and Pantaleano complied with all aspects of the breaking rule.

Oh Boy and **Bar Coins** each took a \$20,000 Pennsylvania Stallion Series division on the same card.

Oh Boy sat a patient third for Miller and looked like he could brush by whenever Miller pushed the button.

"He's been winning pretty easy," Miller said. "That's a pleasure. You don't get that very often. I wasn't real worried about the fractions because I figured the horse on the front was the one I had to beat. I hadn't even asked him, and he got to the leader pretty quick."

The Donato Hanover—Hollybrook Lane gelding triumphed geared down in 1:58.2, 2 lengths better than Bigly, with Amour Deaner third. Jason Shaw conditions Oh Boy for Tammy Carter.

Bar Coins rallied from worst to first for trainer/driver Todd Schadel, who owns the son of Bar Hopping—Gold Cora with Christine Schadel, Rick Beinhauer and Regina Beinhauer.

American Courage, Natameri tally in NYSS at Yonkers

Matt Kakaley guided **American Courage** and **Natameri** to victories in the two \$75,900 New York Sire Stakes (NYSS) divisions for 3-year-old colt and gelding pacers that were featured on Friday night's (Aug. 13) program at Yonkers Raceway.

Making his first start at the track since winning the MGM Grand Messenger Stakes final on July 2, American Courage took the first split in 1:52. Starting from post two, he worked his way around pole-sitter Mullinax (Jordan Stratton) for the lead before the :27.3 opening quarter, then was unchallenged through a :56.2

half and a 1:24.3 three-quarters. American Courage got some separation from Mullinax on the last turn, and after that, he kept clear to the wire to score by a length and a quarter. Mullinax was a good second, and Hidden Assassin (Jim Marohn Jr.) was a best-of-the-rest third.

American Courage is an American Ideal colt trained by Travis Alexander for owner/breeder Fiddler's Creek Stables LLC. This was American Courage's 12th win from 16 career starts, and he has now earned \$520,334. Sent off at 1-9, he paid \$2.10 across the board and was atop a \$5.20 exacta and a \$17.40 trifecta.

In the other flight, Kakaley and Natameri secured the pocket spot behind 1-2 favorite Town Gossip (Joe Bongiorno) and watched as he reached the quarter in :27.1 and the half in :55.3. On the third turn Southwind Petyr (Jason Bartlett) attacked first-over out of fourth, and he would move up quickly into second prior the 1:23.3 three-quarters, then advanced to get alongside Town Gossip on the final bend.

Town Gossip was able to fend off Southwind Petyr and turned for home first, but Kakaley found a seam up the pylons in the stretch with Natameri, and he had the kick to go with the space, getting up to win by a head in 1:51.2. Town Gossip had to settle for runner-up honors, and Southwind Petyr wound up third from a second-over I'll Drink To That (Marohn Jr.).

Another American Ideal colt, Natameri is trained by Jessica Okusko for owner Purple Haze Stables LLC. Natameri, who was bred by Robert Newman, has compiled a record of 6-2-1 from 13 lifetime tries, and he has now pocketed \$85,144. He returned \$7.20 to win as the 5-2 second choice and led a \$13.20 exacta and a \$24.60 trifecta.

Kakaley also won one of three \$15,000 New York Excelsior "A" Series races with So Surreal gelding **Surrealin** in 1:54.1 for trainer Paul Kelley and owner Purple Haze Stables LLC. The other Excelsior "A" contests were won by Bolt The Duer colt **Bolt Power** in 1:52.2 for driver Jason Bartlett, trainer Andrew Adamczyk, and owner Bay Pond Racing Stable, and American Ideal colt **Issac** in 1:53.2 for driver Mark MacDonald, trainer George Ducharme, and owner Amy Cable.

One \$6,500 New York Excelsior "B" Series test was also held,

with Art Major gelding **A B Collins** taking a 1:55.1 decision for Bartlett and owner/trainer Carl Tirella.

The New York Sire Stakes circuit visits Yonkers Raceway again next week, as the 2-year-old trotting fillies will be in action on Thursday night (Aug. 19).

Fillies red hot in Ohio Sires Stakes Action

Trainer Chris Beaver harnessed the first two winners of the Ohio Sires Stakes (OHSS) for 2-year-old trotting fillies on a pleasant, mildly humid Friday night (Aug. 13) at Scioto Downs.

Beaver watched as his **Gabbys C Note** trotted to a front-stepping 1:56.4 triumph for driver Brett Miller in the first \$40,000 OHSS division and returned to the winner's circle in the second \$40,000 OHSS division as **Caviar Roxie Due** won easily in a leisurely 1:58.2. Caviar Roxie Due is now three for three in the four-leg series, having won legs one and two in 1:58.4 and 1:58.2. Beaver owns the filly in partnership with Steve Zeehandelar, Tim Homan, and VIP Internet Stable. The filly left the gate as the 4-5 favorite for driver Aaron Merriman, besting 9-1 What's Up Cupcake (Tyler Smith), with 23-1 Lady Ruth (Dan Noble) garnering third-place honors.

Caviar Roxie Due, a daughter of Triumphant Caviar, sits atop the OHSS standings with 153 points, 50 points ahead of stablemate Gabbys C Note, who is also a daughter of Triumphant Caviar. Owned by Beaver, Beaver, and Zeehandelar, Gabby's C Note captured leg one in 1:58.1. Finishing behind the 1-9 favorite was 18-1 Martysmagicmoment (Ronnie Wrenn, Jr.) with 18-1 Kirsi Dream (Mike Wilder) third.

Lady Camryn held on in late stretch to get her first career victory in the third \$40,000 OHSS contest for 2-year-old trotting fillies. The daughter by What The Hill was piloted by Dan Noble as the 4-1 choice, besting 4-5 favorite Sweet On Pete (Anthony MacDonald) by a head in 1:58.2, with 8-1 Blaze of Justice (Tyler



Smith) third. Owned by breeder Joyce McClelland, Lady Camryn is trained by Virgil Morgan, Jr. and now has \$33,625 in earnings.

Hot Shot Temptress stormed to a decisive 1:53 triumph in the first of two \$50,000 Ohio Sires Stakes for 2-year-old pacing fillies. Aaron Merriman was behind the 3-5 favorite for trainer Kyle Ater and owner Ivy Holdings of Apple Creek, OH. The homebred daughter of McArdle notched her second victory in this series, having won the second leg in 1:51.2. She easily bested 5-1 Dragon Lady (Chris Page), with 7-2 Spitting Image (Brett Miller) third.

Sea Silk kept her undefeated win streak in place, capturing the second \$50,000 Ohio Sires Stakes for freshman pacing fillies. Driven by Chris Page for trainer Ronnie Burke, the daughter of Downbytheseaside left the gate as the 3-5 favorite and held off the hard trying 3-1 Cape Cod Hanover (Mike Wilder) followed by 12-1 Mermaid By The Sea (Ronnie Wrenn, Jr.) 12-1. Owned by Burke Racing, Weaver Bruscemi, Knox Services and Hatfield Stables, Sea Silk was bred by Steiner Stock Farm and now has five career victories and \$160,000 in earnings.

Freshman fillies sparkle in Friday night spotlight

Ontario's talented 2-year-old pacing fillies returned to Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Grassroots action at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Friday (Aug. 13) and looked sharp in all five \$22,150 divisions.

Shanghai Seelster captured the first contest with a pocket trip in behind pacesetter Motovation. Starting from Post 2, driver Doug McNair tucked the filly in behind Motovation as she rang up fractions of :28.1 and :58.2 and then tipped out heading past the 1:27.1 three-quarters. Motovation put up a fight, but Shanghai Seelster got a head in front at the 1:55.1 finish. Winx closed for third and favorite B My Sunshine was fourth. (**replay here: Shanghai Seelster**)

"She's getting better each week. She has a nice, big gait and she's learning," said McNair, who was a head short with the filly off a similar trip in an Aug. 5 overnight. "Last week she hung a little bit in the stretch, this week she got by just enough to win. I hope she stays on the right track."

McNair steers Shanghai Seelster for his father, trainer Gregg McNair of Guelph, and owner Steve Heimbecker of Waterloo, ON. The win was the first lifetime for the Bettors Delight daughter, who was a \$151,960 purchase out of the 2020 London Virtual Yearling Sale.

In the second division, **Morethanmyhometown** sprinted from sixth to first in the final quarter to post a 1:55.4 win in her Ontario Sires Stakes debut. Her stablemate, the betting favorite Crème Delight, was second and Sake Tumi was third. (**replay here: Morethanmyhometown**)

"She's a little filly with a big heart," said driver Chris Christoforou.

"She was uncovered for most of the second quarter, picked up some live cover around the half and was very determined in the stretch; a big effort."

Christoforou piloted the Hes Watching daughter to the win for trainer Murray Brethour of Sunderland and owner Peyton Scott of Douro-Dummer, ON. Although new to the provincial stakes program, Morethanmyhometown is no stranger to the winner's circle. She was victorious at Grand River Raceway on July 23 and Georgian Downs on Aug. 7.

Driver Sylvain Filion put **Delight Bayama** on the front before the halfway marker in the third division and the Bettors Delight daughter dug in down the stretch to hold off fan favorite Velvet Stinger in a personal best 1:54.1. Ribbon Ridge was two lengths behind the duelling leaders in third. (**replay here: Delight Bayama**)

"I'm always happy to win with one of my dad's," said Milton, ON resident Filion, whose father Yves Filion's Bayama Farms Inc. of Saint-Andre-D'Argenteuil, QC bred and owns Delight Bayama. "She's a very nice filly out of Rebeka (Bayama) and she's still green, so she should improve."

Jean Tourigny of Becancour, QC trains Delight Bayama, who is the third foal from \$731,637 winner Rebeka Bayama. The filly was also victorious in the July 20 Grassroots Leg at Woodbine Mohawk Park and a July 8 overnight at Woodbine Mohawk Park, giving her a record of three wins and one second in four lifetime starts.

Favorite **Dewitt For Josie** scored her second Grassroots win in the fourth division, delivering a gritty effort up the outer lane that saw her squeak by pacesetter Novella Seelster at the 1:55.1 finish. A photograph was required to separate the duelling fillies, who finished one length ahead of St Lads Bijou. (**replay here: Dewitt For Josie**)

"She's a nice big filly. When I first sat behind her I was impressed," said driver Louis-Philippe Roy of Guelph, ON. "She is full of talent, but she sometimes lacks in her willingness. Tonight she felt really good coming first up, I thought she would win easily, but she kind of stayed nose-to-nose with the leader.

"I'm happy with the win, but I think she has the talent to be more dominant."

Rene Bourassa trains Dewitt For Josie for Gilles Caouette of Sudbury, ON. The Sportswriter daughter opened her career with a win in the July 6 Grassroots Leg at Georgian Downs and Roy drove her for the first time in the July 18 Gold Series Leg at Georgian, where she finished third.

Warrawee Xpat wrapped up the Grassroots portion of Friday's program with a 1:55 gate-to-wire victory over Girl Scout Cookie and Galleria Seelster. (**replay here: Warrawee Xpat**)

The win was the Sportswriter daughter's second in Grassroots action and, added to a third-place result in the season opener, puts her at the top of the division standings with 112 points.

Doug McNair stepped into Warrawee Xpat's race bike for the first time on Friday, steering the fan favorite to the personal best effort for trainer Gabriella Sasso of Cambridge and owners Jeffrey Courchesne of Cambridge and Martwest Racing Stable of Mississauga, ON.

"I was Johnny-on-the-spot. Jody (Jamieson) had to go race in Indiana and I didn't have one in the race, so I got to drive her," said McNair of the assignment. "She's not very big, but she does everything right; just a sweetheart to drive."

The 2-year-old pacing fillies will have their next chance to pad their point totals when the Grassroots program stops at Hanover Raceway on Sept. 4.

Fresh faces shake up the Grassroots standings

A trio of fresh faces appeared in the Grassroots winner's circle at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Thursday, (Aug. 12) as 3-year-old trotting fillies **P L Opportunity**, **Midnight Miracle** and **Great Dane** all captured their first Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) wins of the season.

P L Opportunity and driver Trevor Henry won the first \$22,150 division with a charge down the stretch that saw them reel in four rivals and stop the teletimer in a personal best 1:54.3. I Da Princess finished two and one-quarter lengths behind the winner in second and Lifeintheslammer stayed game for third. (replay here: P L Opportunity)

"I told Trevor, I said, 'God himself, if he was driving, he wouldn't know how to get out around that last turn," said owner/trainer Matt Dupuis of Rockwood, ON. "It really worked out good."

Starting from Post 8, P L Opportunity left well and was sitting third when favorite Tipsy In Dixie reached the :27.4 quarter. P L Opportunity then found herself shuffled back to sixth when Fox Valley Liza took over before the :57.2 half and Lifeintheslammer led the charge up the outer lane to a 1:25.3 three-quarters. Fortunately, Henry was able to find a seam as the fillies powered out of the final turn and P L Opportunity sprinted home for her second straight win in just her sixth lifetime start.

"I just took it really easy with her and never asked her too much and she's just getting better and better all the time," said Dupuis, who did not race the daughter of Kadabra and P L Indyanaca last season. "Her mother was really, really fast, but she was really, really crazy so we've been really careful with her. I drove her myself at the start, made sure she didn't leave and everything, and now I've given her to Trevor. He really likes her, says she's easy to drive, not hot or anything."

The second \$22,150 division saw **Midnight Miracle** and driver Bob McClure leave sharply from Post 6 and settle in behind Pixies Lady through a :27 quarter and :57 half. Heading by the 1:25.4 three-quarters McClure put the fan favorite on the front and Midnight Miracle was on cruise control for the remainder of the mile, sailing under the wire five lengths the best in a personal best 1:55.1. Mensa finished second and Classy Carol was third. (**replay here: Midnight Miracle**)

"She was just fringe playing in the Golds, so I said, 'Well, we might as well drop down and see what happens'. We got fortunate tonight, two of the better ones were scratched so that helped a lot," said trainer Mark Etsell of the absence of previous Grassroots winners Fuzzy Angel from Post 2 and Edgewater from Post 7. "She just hasn't been as good this year as she was last year, so to get her turned around would be nice."

Rockwood resident Etsell, Robert Newton of Walkerton and Chuan Tan of Cambridge, ON bred and own Midnight Miracle, who was a Gold Series winner at two, but had finished fourth and seventh in her first two starts at that level this season. The filly scored her first win of the sophomore campaign at Georgian Downs on Aug. 8 and Etsell hopes the back-to-back victories restore the Muscle Mass daughter's confidence heading into the last two Ontario Sires Stakes legs.

Great Dane captured the last \$21,800 division with a gate-to-wire effort from Post 4 that saw her ring up fractions of :27.1, :56.3 and 1:26 before digging in down the stretch to keep a neck in front of Hope So in a personal best 1:54.4. Tealicious rounded out the top three. (**replay here: Great Dane**)

"She's really good like that, we put a set of blinds with holes in them and when she can hear horses coming she is competitive enough that she'll keep trying, keep trying, she'll do all she can," said trainer



Shawn Steacy. "Not the way I mapped the trip out to go, but that's why I was in the barn and James (MacDonald) was on the bike."

Great Dane's 2-year-old campaign was cut short by injury so her connections, owners Mark Steacy of Lansdowne, Natasha Rivest of Brantford, Landmark 13 Racing Stable of Lansdowne and owner/breeder Glengate Farms of Erin, were delighted to see the filly reach the winner's circle for the second straight week. The Muscle Mass daughter was also victorious on Aug. 5 in her third sophomore start.

"I always really liked this horse. I thought she was going to be a hell of a good two-year-old last year, but it just didn't pan out," said Steacy. "I think she can possibly transition to the Golds here soon, I always believed she could be that kind of a filly."

The 3-year-old trotting fillies will return to Woodbine Mohawk Park on Aug. 30 for their fourth Grassroots Leg, while the Gold Series fillies head to Grand River Raceway on Aug. 25.

All three of them return for this round of the championship with Double Deceiver drawing inside the pair from post 4. David Miller retains the drive.

Selfie Queen destroyed her competition in the first preliminary for the fillies, trotting a 1:53 mile under minimal encouragement for driver Dexter Dunn and trainer Nancy Takter. But now the Muscle Hill filly will have to face Richard "Nifty" Norman's promising Walner filly Venerable, who enters off a decisive 1:52 victory in the \$326,850 Jim Doherty Memorial. David Miller will score the 9-5 morning-line choice to the right flank of Selfie Queen from post 4, in a race which also includes first-round winner American Beauty – herself a victor in 1:54.2 with Josert Fonseca listed to drive.

A total of six \$20,000 divisions of the Kentucky Commonwealth Series supplement the 13-race card at Red Mile, with three divisions for the colts and geldings and three for the fillies. First-race post time is at 1 p.m. (EDT).

Grace Hill wins, Fire Start Hanover upset by Mikala in Pocono PASS action

The two 3-year-old pacing fillies who are stablemates in the Nifty Norman barn and who were 1-2 in the Shady Daisy Pace on Hambletonian Day came to The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono on Saturday afternoon (Aug. 14), trying to earn spots in their upcoming Pennsylvania Sire Stakes (PASS) Championship while racing in separate divisions.

The one who won on Hambletonian Day, **Grace Hill**, won again; the one who was second, last year's national divisional champion Fire Start Hanover, did not, and the latter would now need great fortune to qualify for the Championship, which will be held with the other sophomore Championships at Pocono on Saturday, Sept. 4.

Grace Hill was up first, and the daughter of Always B Miki secured a sure spot in the final with a sharp 1:49.3 victory. Andrew McCarthy put her on the lead and rolled down the road in :26.1, :54.3, and 1:22.2; 19-1 shot Chase Lounge, with George Brennan, gave a momentarily thrill when tipping to the Pocono Pike and gaining for a few steps, but Grace Hill dug in and retained a half-length lead at the wire. Fourth in two PASS prelims earlier, the peaking Grace Hill pushed her career earnings to \$369,355 while getting a chance at the Championship for owner Tom Hill.

It was George Brennan, so close in the first division, who won the other cut in the PASS, with another daughter of Always B Miki, **Mikala**, equaling the 1:50.1 mark she earned while winning a previous PASS leg. Heavily favored Fire Start Hanover took back and raced from last, coming her back half in :54.2 while wide most of the way, but in finishing second was no closer than 4¾ lengths to the 5-1 pacesetting Mikala, who cut fractions of :26.3, :55.3, and 1:23.1 prior to her :27 kicker. Nik Drennan is Mikala's trainer, and his Drennan Stable LLC is co-owner with Joseph Davino, Brad Shackman, and Anthony Perretti Farm LLC.

Comprising the unofficial top dozen point-winners in the PASS (the official records are kept by the harness bureau of the PA Horse Racing Commission) are, in order: Mikala; Continualou; Blue Diamond Eyes (the 2020 champion) and Thebeachiscalling (tie); Grace Hill; Marsala Hanover; Incaseyoudidntknow; Always B First; Chase Lounge and So Iresistible (tie); Milieu Hanover; JK Alwaysbalady.

There were also three Stallion Series divisions full of fillies trying to earn a spot in their Championships, all eight of the Stallion Series finals taking place at Philly on Sunday, Sept. 5.

Sire Always B Miki, who swept the Sire Stakes, also produced the co-fastest Stallion Series winner, as **Nashville Elgenna** (out of the storied mare Anndrovette) won in 1:51.1, popping out the pocket to pass pacesetter Podium Girl by 2½ lengths. Andrew McCarthy, who won with Grace Hill, added a StS victory to his

day for trainer Tony Alagna and Crawford Farms Racing.

Also scoring in 1:51.1 was the Captaintreacherous filly **Mackie Hanover**, who fought with challengers on both sides in the stretch before posting a nose decision over So Miki Hanover. Matt Kakaley drove the filly, earlier a 1:50 winner in the StS, for trainer Tom Fanning and owners Howard Taylor and Falcon Racing LLC.

The other Stallion Series divisional winner was the Betting Line filly **Darby Hanover**, who took a new mark of 1:51.3 with an easy triumph for driver Andy Miller, trainer Julie Miller, and the partnership of Andy Miller Stable Inc., Let It Ride Stables Inc., and Mr. Caroll Huffman.

The top dozen unofficial Stallion Series point-earners, in order, read as follows: So Miki Hanover; Mackie Hanover; Classicist; Darby Hanover; Podium Girl; Odds On Whitney (this group's 2020 champion); Fighting Evil and Nashville Elgenna (tie); Tonianne; Star Captain; Shezafreaklikeme; Captains Maid and Filly Speaks (tie).

Winning Ticket undefeated in Ohio Sires Stakes

Seven Ohio Sires Stakes (OHSS) were contested on a pleasant Saturday evening (Aug. 14) at Northfield Park. The fourth and final leg of the series for 3-year-old trotting colts and geldings solidified the top eight contenders who will vie in the \$300,000 Championship, set for Sept. 4 at Northfield.

Sitting atop the standings with nine undefeated starts this season is **Winning Ticket**, who cruised to an easy 1:54.1 triumph for Aaron Merriman in the first of two \$50,000 legs over the Cleveland half-miler. Owned by Chris Beaver, Steve Zeehandelar, Tim Homan and James Burnett, the son of Triumphant Caviar notched his 13th career victory and pushed his career earnings to a hefty \$284,547 with this latest win. Winning Ticket, who was bred by James Bender, has earned \$100,000 in Ohio Sires Stakes competition alone this season, winning his previous OHSS legs in 1:55.3, 1:54, and 1:53.1 before this latest score.

McStoned Again took a new career mark of 1:56 in the second \$50,000 for sophomore trotting colts with Tony Hall at the lines. The son of Wishing Stone is conditioned by Chris Hershberger for owner Sonia Vermlye and picked up his sixth career victory and first in OHSS competition. This homebred finished a solid third in leg 2 and upped his earnings to \$58,745 with this triumph.

A trio of \$40,000 Ohio Sires Stakes for 2-year-old trotting colts saw **Up Blueberry Hill**, **The Mighty Hill** and **Slim Jimmy** all take their respective divisions. Up Blueberry Hill, the 4-1 choice, posted a 1:57 clocking for driver Chris Page and trainer Ron

Burke, with 7-5 favorite The Mighty Hill pacing to a 1:56.1, new track record for a 2-year-old trotting gelding in rein to Aaron Merriman. Chris Beaver trains the son of What The Hill. Slim Jimmy, who hails from the barn of Jason McGinnis and driver Anthony MacDonald, paced to a winning 1:56.3 in his division as the 1-5 favorite.

Round four of the 2021 Ohio Sires Stakes season wraps up next weekend with races on Friday night (Aug. 20) at Scioto Downs for 3-year-old filly trotters and pacers; on Saturday night (Aug. 21) at Scioto Downs for 3-year-old colt pacers, and 2-year-old colt trotters and pacers; and on Sunday night (Aug. 22) at Northfield Park with divisions for 2-year-old filly trotters and pacers.

Ohio Sires Stakes Championships get underway beginning on Saturday, Sept. 4 with four \$85,000 Veteran's Championships for 4-year-olds and up at Scioto Downs, followed by the \$300,000 Championships for 2- and 3-year-olds at Northfield on Sunday, Sept. 5. The \$75,000 Consolation for 2- and 3-year-olds will be raced on Friday, Oct. 2 at Dayton Raceway.

Baillargeon steers two Grassroots winners in Hanover

Driver Mario Baillargeon earned his second straight Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Grassroots double at Hanover Raceway on Saturday (Aug. 14) afternoon, steering **Muscle Up The Gold** and **Gala Halo** to victory in 2-year-old trotting filly action.

"They had this track impeccable today," said Baillargeon, who also scored two wins in Grassroots action at Kawartha Downs last Saturday. "It was nice footing. They had the track real, real good for the 2-year-old trotting fillies."

Baillargeon took advantage of the track conditions in the first \$21,450 division with Muscle Up The Gold, going straight to the front from Post 7 and putting up fractions of :31, 1:03.3 and 1:34 on the way to a two and three-quarter length victory in 2:04. Elisabetta finished second, Opas Faith was third and fan favorite Da Royal Miracle made an early break and finished fifth.

"She was a little green when I first started her at Mohawk (July 27), because she didn't train with much company all winter, but now every start she's more mature," said Baillargeon, who has now piloted the filly to one win, one second and one third. "She's a very handy filly, don't miss a beat. She's not real big, but she's very honest and she's got a big heart. She tries hard and she is very sure-footed, and with two-year-old fillies that's probably the key."

In the first three Grassroots legs the filly has tallied one seventh, one second and one win for a point total of 77. Baillargeon drives the Muscle Up The Goal daughter for trainer Kevin Benn and his co-owner Dennis Chadwick of Napanee, ON, who are also fond of the diminutive trotter.

"We really love her, she isn't big, but she's slick gaited, and she's a little tough," said Benn. "When they're small they've got to have a little feist to them."

Baillargeon also went gate-to-wire with Gala Halo in the third division. From Post 3 the filly trotted to a :30.1 quarter, 1:03.1 half and 1:33.3 three-quarters before cruising home a six and one-half length winner in 2:04.2. Complete Life finished second and favorite Stella Alpha was promoted from fourth to third when Real Good Tan was found to be in violation of the breaking rule.

"She'd never been on a half-mile track and I looked at her before I went on the track and I said, 'Geez, she's a big filly.' So I gave her a little score down, but she was as flat as, you know I could have put a glass of water on her back, so I said we'll try to get around the one and the two," said Baillargeon, who was making his first appearance in the filly's race bike. "And we came down at the corner and I turned around and we had five lengths on the field, so there must have been some breakers, but she went around them four turns like a pro really, for never being on a half-mile track."

The Acton resident engineered the win for trainer Rick Zeron of Oakville, ON and Hutt Racing Stable of Malvern, PA. With one win, one second and one fourth in Grassroots action, the Archangel daughter currently leads the 2-year-old trotting filly division with 83 points.

In the other two Grassroots divisions first-time OSS starters Global News and Lune Duharas emerged victorious.

Starting from Post 4, fan favorites **Global News** and driver James MacDonald delivered a confident front-end effort, sailing through fractions of :30.4, 1:02.3 and 1:33 on their way to a two and one-half length win in 2:04.1. Tioga Sunshine finished second and Okeeheelee was third.

"The main thing is, she wants to do it, and you can work with that," said trainer Blake MacIntosh. "She tries every week and she wants to trot. She wants to do it as much as any horse I've had in a long time."

MacIntosh shares ownership of the Archangel daughter with Stuart McIntosh of Essex, ON and Hutt Racing Stable. The St. George, ON resident was sufficiently impressed with the filly's first lifetime start that Global News may be back in Hanover next Saturday for the Balanced Image Trot eliminations.

"I think we might race her in the Balanced Image next week, just because she trots the turns so well. It's going to be tough, but it's a place to race, she hasn't had much experience and she could use a little experience," said MacIntosh. "Hopefully she'll show some more speed next week and just keeping getting better."

Unlike her peers, Lune Duharas reeled in fan favorite **Allisonann Hanover** in the stretch in the afternoon's final Grassroots division. From Post 4, the Muscle Mass daughter and driver Louis-Philippe

Roy sat third as Allisonann Hanover reeled off fractions of :29.4, 1:01.1 and 1:31.2 and then sprinted down the stretch to a 2:04 victory. Allisonann Hanover was two and one-quarter lengths back in second and Epic Thrill was another length back in third.

"She's a nice filly, still green, and she did it really easy today," said Roy, who made the trip to Hanover just to drive Lune Duharas. "I'm excited to drive her again in the Quebec Finals on Sept. 12."


Bred and owned by Haras De L'Estrie and trained by Denis Gueriel, both of Dunham, QC, Lune Duharas made her career debut in the July 23 leg of the Coupe de l'Avenir at Hippodrome Trois-Rivières, finishing second.

Lune Duharas will miss the next Grassroots Leg, which goes postward Sept. 13 at Woodbine Mohawk Park, but can catch the final event on Sept. 21 at Flamboro Downs. The top 10 point earners from the five regular season legs will compete in the Grassroots Semi-Finals at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Sept. 30, with the top five finishers from each Semi-Final advancing to the Oct. 9 Grassroots Championship.

Inquiry protocols RE: the Meadowlands Pace

RE: Tiger appeals Meadowlands Pace result, calls Charlie May "David" vs. Goliath

This issue is recent history but has been on my mind since the race.

Everyday decisions small and large inexpensive or costly are pragmatically resolved when all the factors are considered. Whether you are purchasing a home, deciding on a school for your children or looking into disqualifying a winner in a major stakes race every morsal of information is useful.

I have mentored many during my 30 years in the judges' stand have always stressed talking to the drivers before making a decision that could cost an owner, trainer and driver a purse check.

Even if the interference is obvious, I talk to the drivers and I can say there have been rare instances where I have been surprised by an important factor unseen in the replay. A call from a driver after the official is posted informing you of an issue that could have influenced your decision is a presiding judge's nightmare.

This practice of not acquiring information from drivers during an inquiry has developed in the last decade based on the premise that the drivers never tell the truth. I agree. In 30 years, I can recall two inquiries where the drivers said straight out, they caused the interference. Otherwise it's a debate. The presiding judge in most instances can use all angles of the replay to get a straight answer. Talk to all the drivers involved, question their actions. A common question I have asked many drivers is "are we looking at the same replay?"

"When you assume you make an ass out of you and me"

Use your experience, the replay and input from the drivers and make the call.

An appeal of an inquiry and subsequent placing in a major stake sans proper protocol was inevitable.

The problem with separate betting entries

If you would like another glaring example of the same trainer having two horses in the race under separate betting, here it is again.

Have your experts watch this race and tell me this shouldn't stir up the bettors who had all their money on the heavy favorite.

In race #2 on Friday (Aug. 13) at Harrah's Hoosier Park, Ron Burke had two horses entered. Dave Miller is on Burke heavy favorite at 4-5 odds.

Burke's other horse goes to the front from the 7 post. Miller is back fifth on the rail and is fighting his horse as the horse wants to go out. He holds the horse in as the parade goes on by him and he is sitting in locked on the rail near the back. The fact that his horse races up the inside for third is meaningless to the bettors and is more so just an insult. Burke's other horse hangs on for the win.

Can anyone, and I mean Miller should, explain to the judges why he did not move his horse when he had a chance. Especially when, by appearances, the horse was trying to go. As a bettor on the favorite I definitely feel cheated. If the top trainer and drivers are doing this, then the sport is in trouble.

As a 50-year bettor I am ready to leave this sport for good.
