Two weeks after an impressive performance on Hambletonian Day, the Svanstedt Stable is ready to add some more tallies to their win column on both sides of the border on Saturday (Aug. 17).

But before they look for another day in the "Sun," at Pocono, and a night on the town, at Mohawk, Team Svanstedt took a few minutes to reflect on the last day of the Championship Meet at The Meadowlands.

For Ake Svanstedt and his wife, Sarah, the first Saturday in August was a busy one.

"We had 17 horses in total racing Saturday [on Hambletonian Day]," Sarah said. "So, you put the entries in and the sheet comes out and then you're like, 'Oh, boy, now we're going to make this happen."

The expression "Team Svanstedt" should be taken literally when it comes to Ake and Sarah's stable.

"I mean, it's a great team behind us from everything, with the horses to get in detention, and shipping, and warm ups, and grooms that know when to be ready," Sarah said. "The whole thing is a huge operation and it's very fun that it works out so well as it does on those days. So, I can't be more proud, and happy, about the people around us, too."

They won almost half of the races they entered — five of 11 on the "Greatest Day in Harness Racing," including two with the second- and third-biggest purses on the card, the \$525,000 Hambletonian Oaks and \$282,000 John Cashman Memorial. They also won a division of the \$240,000 New Jersey Sire Stakes, the fifth biggest purse on the 16-race program.

"I mean, you work with a plan for each single horse and you're trying to peak them when they can and when it's their best chance to make money," Sarah said. "And like those ones, Slip Sliding [Away] and Upallnight [Hanover], that were in a little bit lower division, it's their chance to show off on those days when they're not in the biggest races. So, everything worked out by the plan."

Even though she wasn't driving on this particular card, Sarah still put in her share of miles.

"I was warming up everyone almost because [Ake] was in the winner's circle or catching a breath between the races," Sarah said. "I don't know how many trips I went around there, but it was a lot.

"I know the horses as well as he does and if they don't warm up the way they normally do, or are on a line, or it seems like their energy is not there, we have a conversation about how they warmed up, every one of them, after every race. I need to see the horse; how it hits the track that day."

Sarah did admit to taking a short break from her warm ups to take her colors off for the Oaks.

"I was like, 'I'm going to get changed because this can actually happen that we can win the Oaks," she said, adding with a laugh, "so I wanted to be fresh and clean."

In addition to winning the Oaks with Warrawee Michelle, the Cashman with Jiggy Jog S, and the New Jersey Sire Stakes 2-yearold male trot with Nordic Catcher S, the Svanstedts won both divisions of the Continentalvictory with the aforementioned Upallnight Hanover and Slip Sliding Away.

When dealing with multiple entrants in the same race, it's obviously impossible for Ake to drive them all and sometimes he doesn't even get to choose.

Because the Svanstedts are co-owners on several of the horses that Ake trains, the rules dictate that he must drive one of his own. Which could be a little difficult for the competitive horseman since sometimes his own is not his best chance to win.

Three of the five Svanstedt victories contributed to the Hambletonian Day six-bagger for driver Dexter Dunn, including the one with Jiggy Jog S.

When asked if it bothers him that he's not the one sitting behind "Jiggy," Ake was pretty matter of fact.

"No, I'm getting used to it," Ake said. "I want to drive the 2-year-olds because they can change from race to race. They don't act the same every time. But when they are 3-year-olds, they are always the same in every race. Then it doesn't matter as much, then they can have [catch] drivers.

"But I want to drive the 2-year-olds because I train them all and know them better and maybe need to teach them the right way."

In the Cashman, Ake finished second driving Southwind Tyrion, who he co-owns.

"Dexter and Jiggy have been building this whole success story up together," Sarah said. "He knows her and has been behind her in almost every start since she was 3. So, I mean, you can't take away that fun and joy for any of the group or the horse or anything when you have her in the barn.

"I was watching [the Cashman]... and 'Tyrion' wasn't that tiger behind the gate... So, I'm like, 'Oh God, now he's going to get nowhere, and then I could see that Jiggy was sitting on his back and that was the only thing, I was like, at least Jiggy will have a good ride out of this.

"And thank God, Tyrion did the race he did and then it's Jiggy, that's the winner. It's great. But it's tough when a horse does the race like Tyrion did. Normally, it's not a very good ending and he fought his heart out, but it was her that was passing him, so I was fine with it."





Ake did have two driving wins on the card with horses that he co-owns, including the top distaff prize, the Oaks with Warrawee Michelle. His other came with 2025 Hambletonian hopeful Nordic Catcher S.

"I mean, [Ake] loves to compete," Sarah said, adding with a laugh, "and he's the same kind of way when we're training at home, too. Sometimes, it's like, 'Let's race.'

"He loves to race and it's also a joy when you know your own horse. You know how it has trained and if it has anything that can help to ride on the helmet longer than it maybe would have done with another driver. It's just like you know your horses, and then it's also fun to race them."

This was the Svanstedts' first Oaks victory after coming so close in 2023 with Bond, who was beaten a neck at the wire by Heaven Hanover. Although Nancy Takter won The Meadowlands training title for wins, Ake led all Big M trainers in money earned.

The Svanstedts have 13 entered to compete on Saturday, including four — Warrawee Michelle, Jiggy Jog S, Nordic Catcher S, and Slip Sliding Away — that won on Hambletonian Day. There are 10 entered on Sun Stakes Day at Pocono as well as three heading north for the William Wellwood eliminations at Mohawk.


Although their days are still plenty busy and probably won't get any easier until after the Breeders Crown, the Svanstedts appreciate looking back on their big Hambletonian Day.

Legendary' performer ready for Hempt

Legendary Hanover is not history's fastest 3-year-old pacer — not yet at least — but he has put his name in the record book when it comes to speed. With his 1:46.3 win in the Meadowlands Pace and 1:46.2 score in the Cane Pace, the colt became the first-ever sophomore with multiple sub-1:47 victories in a season.


And he did it in consecutive starts, falling just shy of Confederate's 1:46.1 world record for a 3-year-old pacer.

"I still wake up every morning and pinch myself to make sure this is reality," Legendary Hanover's trainer, Anthony Beaton, said with a laugh. "I thought this is kind of the caliber of horse he was. But is he going to go that fast? You never know. But the way they drive them now, they're just like race cars. The fact he can come right back and do it again, he's an amazing animal. He's just special."

Legendary Hanover's next start comes Saturday (Aug. 17) in the \$300,000 Max C. Hempt Memorial for 3-year-old pacers at Mohegan Pennsylvania's Pocono Downs. The colt is the 2-1 morning-line favorite and will leave from post 7 in a field of eight with regular driver James MacDonald.

The Hempt is part of a Sun Stakes Saturday card at the northeast Pennsylvania five-eighths-mile oval that also features the \$300,000 Earl Beal, Jr. Memorial for 3-year-old trotters, \$250,000 James M. Lynch Memorial for 3-year-old female pacers, and \$250,000 Delmonica Hanover for 3-year-old female trotters.

Racing begins at 2:30 p.m. (EDT) Saturday at Pocono Downs. For free programs, visit the Pennsylvania Harness Horsemen's Association website **here**.



Legendary Hanover was Canada's O'Brien Award winner for best 2-year-old male pacer in 2023, when he finished worse than second only once in nine starts, winning six. So far this season, he's been worse than second only once in eight races, winning five. He brings a three-race victory streak to the Hempt, which includes his Meadowlands Pace triumph on July 13 and Cane Pace win on Aug. 3, both at The Meadowlands.

The son of Huntsville—Lillian Hanover is a half-brother to Linedrive Hanover, who Beaton has also trained. Linedrive Hanover holds the Canadian record for pacing on a half-mile track, 1:49, and has a lifetime mark of 1:47.

"I knew how good Linedrive was, and how he could carry his speed, but the first time I sat behind [Legendary Hanover], it was like, 'Wow, this is a powerful animal for a 2-year-old," Beaton said. "He was a powerful individual from day one. And as he's developed, he's gotten more powerful and stronger. He's got a huge set of lungs on him and just doesn't get tired.

"This fella just had something about him that I knew he was going to be a great horse. He's just such a professional."

Legendary Hanover, with his 11 wins and four seconds in 17 career races, has earned \$854,669 for owners Eric Good, West Wins Stable, and Mark Dumain. The colt's start at Pocono will be his first on a track other than a mile or seven-eighths.

"I don't see that being an issue; he's a very good-gaited horse," Beaton said. "He seems to handle whatever we throw at him."

Captain's Quarters, who finished third in the Cane Pace, is the 7-2 second choice in the Hempt. He will leave from post 2 with Scott Zeron driving for trainer Herbert Holland. Captain Albano, who won the Adios in his most recent start, is the 9-2 third choice. He will leave from post 5 with Todd McCarthy in the sulky for trainer Noel Daley.

The world record for a 3-year-old pacer on a five-eighths is 1:47.1, set by Papi Rob Hanover in 2020 at Hollywood Casino at The Meadows.

Of course, Legendary Hanover is not the only stakes-winning 3-year-old colt in Beaton's stable. Nijinsky, who in June won the North America Cup, has won seven of eight races this season with his lone setback being a second-place finish to Legendary Hanover in the Meadowlands Pace.

Nijinsky will make his next start tonight (Aug. 16) in the fourth round of the Ontario Sire Stakes Gold at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

"We're trying our best to split them up," Beaton said about Legendary Hanover and Nijinsky. "With the way [Nijinsky's] schedule worked out, we wanted to focus on the Golds with him. He's been super."

Beaton, who trains Nijinsky for owners West Wins, John Fielding, and Dumain, has seen his stable earn \$1.97 million in purses this year, already surpassing his career-best \$1.75 million in 2023.

"It's just been a crazy year with the races we're winning and the way the horses have been racing," Beaton said. "It's been amazing."

THE VIEW FROM WOODBINE MOHAWK PARK

Best of both breeds

The King's Plate Mohawk watch party builds excitement for Wellwood, Peaceful Way elims.

Before regally-bred 2-year-old trotters take to the track at Woodbine Mohawk Park this Saturday (Aug. 17) night, the Campbellville, ON grandstand will play host to a different breed of racing royalty.

Eliminations for the William Wellwood (open) and Peaceful Way (filly) stakes for freshman trotters bring Grand Circuit action back to Mohawk for the first time since June 27 and 28, when Tompkins-Geers Stakes divisions for 2-year-olds of both gaits were raced there for the first time.

The Wellwood and Peaceful Way elims will follow the biggest race in Canadian horse racing: the 165th running of the King's (formerly Queen's) Plate, taking place at Woodbine Racetrack on Saturday afternoon.


While many harness tracks celebrate Kentucky Derby Day with on-track festivities to accompany the simulcast, Woodbine Mohawk Park is taking the 2024 King's Plate to another level.

Woodbine Entertainment's senior manager of communications told HRU that bringing the Woodbine Racetrack party to Woodbine Mohawk Park was a concept many months in the making.

"It came up during the planning, over the winter months," said Mark McKelvie. "When we were looking ahead to this year's King's Plate at Woodbine, it was being run on a Saturday. It's often been run on Sundays, when we're not racing at Mohawk, but because it's on a Saturday, we have racing at Mohawk that night, which means that we could add a viewing party at Mohawk."

McKelvie said racegoers in Milton and surrounding area might be unable to travel to Woodbine for the King's Plate card, which has a 12:25 p.m. (ET) first-race post time, "but if they wanted to be at Mohawk... they can still enjoy Canada's most prestigious horse race."

The \$1-million King's Plate itself has a 6:10 p.m. (ET) post time. Mohawk's viewing party will run all afternoon, with grandstand doors opening at noon. There is no admission fee.

"We're one company," said McKelvie. "It made sense to add a little something out at Mohawk to make the day a bit more special.

"It's an opportunity for fans to dress up as if they were going to the King's Plate, so wear your best, whether that's the hats, the fascinators, the three-piece suits... Whatever you would wear to [Woodbine] on King's Plate Day, we want you to get in that spirit at Mohawk."

There will be live music from 4 to 6 p.m., with a to-beannounced location McKelvie called "weather-dependent."

"We're just trying to create that party-like atmosphere that people on-site at Woodbine would be experiencing," McKelvie said. "We're just trying to replicate that at Mohawk."

McKelvie recommended that customers make reservations for the Mohawk Harvest Kitchen and Trackside Bar & Patio in advance.

"The restaurants will both be open," he said. "Typically, the restaurants would only be open during the live racing hours. There are going to be special drinks being served and some additional dining options that wouldn't be available on a regular day.

"For the hardcore horseplayer, they can reserve their carrels as well."

Carrels can be booked by calling 647-394-8319; restaurant reservations can be made online at **woodbine.com/mohawk/dining-at-mohawk/**.

While Mohawk's simulcast area is open every Saturday, McKelvie said staff were anticipating greater numbers than usual.

"I would expect a lot of people will probably come out a little later in the afternoon, closer to when the King's Plate happens, and then stay for live [harness] racing," he said.


Tickets for King's Plate Day at Woodbine Racetrack have been selling briskly.


"We're in a pretty good spot with ticket sales," McKelvie said on Monday (Aug. 12). "We're probably 80 per cent, if not more, sold out at this time. We're expecting a really good crowd."

The Mohawk watch party is presented as a crossover event with something for followers of both breeds represented by Woodbine.

"There is a pretty strong following of the Woodbine product, whether that's standardbred or thoroughbred," said McKelvie. "I'm in a unique position where I work on both breeds. I find that on a Saturday, when the thoroughbreds wrap up around 7 p.m. and Mohawk starts, there are still a lot of horseplayers around who've been there all afternoon and start wagering on Mohawk as well."

Arriving on the heels of 2022 Queen's Plate champion Moira's victory in the \$500,000 Beverly D. Stakes, on Aug. 11 at Colonial Downs, this year's King's Plate is expected to draw a strong viewing audience. Her stakes-record 2:01.48 victory in the mileand-a-quarter Canadian Triple Crown jewel came in the last Queen's Plate. It was renamed for King Charles after the death of Queen Elizabeth II.





"It's worth mentioning that we've got network [television] coverage of the King's Plate, a two-hour broadcast on Sportsnet and Citytv this Saturday from 4:30 to 6:30, so we're going to use that to show everything going on around the King's Plate," said McKelvie. "It's a lot more than a horse race."

The King's Plate draws people who may otherwise spend little time at any racetrack. McKelvie said that makes the broadcast a powerful outreach tool for Ontario racing in general.

"I think anytime we're on-air with any racing, whether it's thoroughbred or standardbred, it's definitely raising awareness for people to get out to their local tracks," he said. "Whether it's through Ontario Racing's 'Unfiltered' show, or the ad campaigns they're doing, there's been a big push through television to get people out to their local tracks.

"A race like the King's Plate or the North America Cup, they're opportunities to get people out to the track, to put on a big party, a big event. I think whether you're a thoroughbred fan or a standardbred fan, you could go to either of those and have a blast, so I think that's where the crossover is: Just getting people out to the track, one way or another."

A good horse might just be a good horse, with more commonalities than differences among their followers today. Moira, Canada's 2022 thoroughbred Horse of the Year, won the Queen's Plate for X-Men Racing, an ownership group which included prominent standardbred owners John Fielding, Robert LeBlanc, Clay Horner, Daniel Plouffe, and David Anderson.

"I get a kick out of it when I talk to trainers and drivers at Mohawk," said McKelvie "They pay attention to what's going on, on the thoroughbred side, and even vice-versa. There are quite a few people on the thoroughbred side, whether they're owners

or trainers, who, if they're from Ontario, typically have that exposure to harness racing, just with the number of [harness] tracks in different parts of the province, compared with only two thoroughbred tracks and one quarter horse track."

After the King's Plate party, harness racing returns to center stage at Mohawk.

"We've seen really healthy crowds on-track all summer long," said McKelvie. "Saturday night is kind of the start of the Grand Circuit meet: We have the Wellwood and Peaceful Way eliminations. So we see an uptick in our sales and our wagering and our on-track attendance, really from this Saturday right through to the Mohawk Million [Sept. 21]."





HOLLYWOOD'S HITS

Many memorable moments happened on August 16

What is it about August 16 anyway? On that date, there was greatness everywhere. Here's a look at notable names from just that day.

In 1901, Dan Patch was 5 years old and racing in Brighton, MA. He was not, yet, the Dan Patch we know about today, but was quickly getting there. That year would mark the first of many Dan Patch days in his birthplace of Oxford, IN.

But on Aug. 16, his sire Joe Patchen was also racing. He was 11 years old and at the tail end of a 100 53-39-5 career that netted him near \$50,000. Father and son even warmed up side by side. But this was to be the final pair of races for dad — finishing well back twice despite a stellar career which earned him the nickname "The Iron Horse."

Joe Patchen would resume his siring career and would actually outlive Dan Patch by seven months. He died on Feb. 18, 1917. Dan Patch died on July 11, 1916.

BABE, ELVIS AND NIATROSS

On Aug. 16 in 1948, Babe Ruth died. Then, in 1977 Elvis died on the same date. But in 1980, Aug. 16 was the day Niatross did something that was unreal — even for him. He set his fifth consecutive world record.

MAGIC MAN'S MAGIC DAY

Aug. 16, 1984 was, quite possibly, the sport's most eventful/colorful day ever. On that date, the richest harness race ever was contested — the \$2,161,000 Woodrow Wilson. Nihilator won it for Bill O'Donnell with Ernie Gaskin training for the Billy Haughton stable. Bob Boni and Lou Guida were the principal owners.

The same day had other drama/notable happenings. At Springfield, Fancy Crown set the world filly record 1:53.4 to solidify her position as Horse of the Year.

Chris Boring also joined in the fun with an all-time sophomore best 1:50.3 with his standout Colt Forty-Six. (Cornstalk had won in world record time of 1:53 4, but that was on Aug. 15).

O'Donnell, if he wasn't, yet, recognized as the Magic Man, this day sealed it. He drove Fancy Crown to a world record, won five races at Springfield and then flew to The Meadowlands where he won five more and set another world record, this time for a 2-year-old, with Nihilator (1:52.4).

MADONNA AND SI

Two Aug. 16 entrants that almost made the cut include Madonna, born on that day in 1958 (a game-changer for sure) and *Sports Illustrated* hitting the stands for the very first time in 1954 on that same date.

SUN STAKES NOTES

The Lynch Memorial started in 1970 in split divisions for... wait for it... \$6,062 each.

Actually, from 1976-80 the Lynch was previously known as both the Miller Memorial and for just a single year the Miss Pocono (1997).

The Earl Beal started in 2011 with Dejarmbro kicking it off. Then, in 2014, Father Patrick set a 1:50.2 track and world standard.

The Max Hempt Memorial is named for a giant in many ways — especially in the Keystone State. Hempt was the owner and his family bred the 1954 Horse of the Year Stenographer, who has the distinction of living longer than any other HOY-35.

Hempt also bred-and later stood 1976 HOY Keystone Ore.

Remember it was in the 2000 Hempt that HOY Gallo Blue Chip was second to Sam Francisco.

This year's Sun Stakes card has three sets of brothers in action: James/Mark MacDonald, Mattias/Marcus Melander and Andy/ Todd McCarthy.

Leamington Raceway kicks off 2024 meet with its highest handle in 11 years

The track opened its meet last Sunday with fans putting more than \$86,000 through the mutuels. Events still to come include Bob McIntosh Day on Aug. 25 and the return of Hall of Fame race caller Frank Salive to his hometown on Sept. 8.

If opening day at Leamington Raceway was any indication of what lies ahead, the 2024 campaign could be a historic one for the Southwestern Ontario racing venue.

On day one of its 12-week program on Sunday (Aug. 11), the quaint half-mile track generated over \$86,000 — its highest single-card handle since Learnington reopened in 2013 — and as track announcer Nathan Bain put it, that's no small feat.

"It was incredible," Bain said. "The entire place was packed, the crowd was screaming, and that definitely makes my job easier as an announcer because you really feed off the crowd.

"You could hear the cheering echoing throughout the track, and that's pretty exciting for racing these days."

For Bain, who spends the first half of his summer about an hour northeast calling the races at Dresden Raceway, the transition between tracks is typically seamless.

That's because, in addition to most of the staff migrating over from Dresden, the horse population and driver colony also remains largely the same.

While Bain noted that some horsepeople take their craft elsewhere, the ones that descend on Leamington tend to have been doing so for some time.

The 22-year-old said that level of familiarity was apparent on opening day as the 10-race card ran "quite fast."

It was especially expeditious for driver Garrett Rooney, who added four tallies to his season total (208 and counting).

"He's been having a strong year at all the tracks," Bain said. "Fans are familiar with him, and they love to watch him at Leamington." And for good reason.

The Iona, ON-based reinsman paced Leamington's driver colony in wins (40), earnings (\$126,42), win percentage (37.7) and UDRS (.514) through the 2023 season.

With the first day of the meet officially in the rearview, Bain and Co's. focus now shifts to other important dates on the calendar.

One of which being Bob McIntosh Day on Aug. 25.

The revered dual Hall of Fame trainer died on July 28 at the age of 71.

"It's going to be a jam-packed day," Bain said. "We were originally going to do something to honor Bob that day and have him there. But unfortunately, his recent passing happened, and we changed it right away to honor his legacy.

"He's just such a big part of racing here in Windsor-Essex, obviously, being in both Hall of Fames, and he still had a pretty active stable, and was competing at the top level. The news is a huge shake up for everybody, but we're looking forward to honoring him on what should be a very special day."

McIntosh's family, friends, and fans will gather to celebrate the legendary horseman's legacy with stories, as well as a display featuring photos and a video tribute.

As for Bain, who will be occupying his regular post that day, the memorial is a chance to reflect on the profound impact one man had on harness racing in Southwestern Ontario.

"To see someone like Bob honored, especially being from my own area, it's really unique to see all the amazing things he accomplished," Bain said. "After Windsor Raceway, a lot of people left the area, but Bob is one of the few people that continued to operate his stable in Windsor after the closure.

"It's been very cool to see how many good horses have come out of an area where I've been my whole life. That's something very special." Coinciding with Bob McIntosh Day is Learnington Raceway's open house, which will treat fans who register to a behind-thescenes tour of the property.

The on-air broadcast will also feature a guest appearance from popular harness racing analyst and commentator Robert Reid, Jr.

Looking ahead, the second Sunday in September marks the return of Leamington royalty in Hall of Fame announcer Frank Salive, who is set to return to his hometown track for a day in his honor.

The renowned race caller officially hung up the headset in 2021, but a return to the booth, even for a day, has always been in the cards.

"This is something we've wanted to do for a while, and I had been talking to Frank about it," Bain said. "We couldn't make it happen last year, but Sept. 8 seemed to be a good day.

"Frank used to announce Leamington, and he's a Leamington native, so the area means a lot to him, and especially to what he's gone on to do. He's in the Hall of Fame. He's called races at Pompano, Woodbine, Fort Erie, Western Fair, you name it, and accomplished so many incredible things."

Although the finer details are still being ironed out, Bain said the plan is for Salive to announce approximately five races and then head downstairs for a meet and greet.

Throughout his travels and many successes, the man with some 200,000 calls on his resume has always found time for Leamington.

"Frank's a really good person," Bain said. "He reaches out to me from time to time, and tunes into Leamington almost every week. It goes to show just how much Leamington Raceway means to him."



Since making its triumphant return 11 years ago, Leamington has been a boon for the present and future well-being of harness racing in Essex County and beyond.

"It's been such a great area for racing partly because it's very close to the border," Bain said. "When Windsor Raceway closed, there was such a massive fan base and those betters and fans wanted something, not necessarily to replace the raceway but a spot to enjoy racing. The fans continue to prove just how much of a staple this area is for harness racing in Ontario.

"It's amazing to see how much people have supported it. We'll race deep into the fall and people still come out every week and pack the grandstand. It just goes to show how dedicated they are."

The Last Martini served up the first career loss to Cowgirl Hanover after she went gate-to-wire in the lone \$102,500 division of the New York Sire Stakes for 2-year-old pacing fillies on Wednesday (Aug. 14) evening at Batavia Downs.

Sent off as the prohibitive 1-9 betting favorite, Cowgirl Hanover (Doug McNair) got away third as stablemate The Last Martini (Jason Bartlett) grabbed the lead and got to the quarter in :29. With the short field following in single file, Bartlett throttled down the half even more to a :59.1 saunter and still didn't get any opposition from behind until well into the second circuit.

Halfway up the backstretch, McNair finally pulled Cowgirl Hanover, who quickly made her way to second in a now up tempo :28-flat third panel. As the pair made their way around the last turn, Cowgirl Hanover got to within a halflength of The Last Martini, but that would be as close as she would get. The Last Martini paced furiously down the lane and refused to give up any ground at all to Cowgirl Hanover and won by a half-length in a 1:54.4 mile that featured a :27.3 final quarter.

It was the second straight win for The Last Martini (\$19.80) and it pushed her earnings to \$110,399 for owner Glenview Livestock. Jared Bako trains the winner who was bred by Crawford Farms.

There were also four \$20,000 Excelsior stakes on the card and these are the winners in order of race.

Another big winner on Wednesday was Huntsville, who sired all five NYSS and Excelsior winners and also 10 of the 15 horses who hit the board in those same five races.

Brookview Fancy left from post 3 as the even-money favorite in the \$66,500 first division which served as the ninth race on the card. The quintet remained in straight-alignment on the backstretch with Brookview Fancy tapping the brakes to the halfway point in :56.3. Brookview Fancy extended her lead to two-lengths over

pocket-sitter Kaks The Boss (driven by Kyle Wilfong) at three-quarters in 1:25.3 while Loveyoucookie (Ricky Macomber, Jr.) stalked from third.

Brookview Fancy cut the corner two-lengths clear as Loveyoucookie tipped wide to begin her rally at the top of the stretch. Loveyoucookie surged to the outside of Brookview Fancy in deep-stretch, with the fillies needing the photo-finish camera to settle the outcome. Brookview Fancy reached the wire first a head clear in 1:52.4 over the charging Loveyoucookie, with Kaks The Boss finishing third.

Trained by Aaron Stutzman, Brookview Fancy has won three of four on the year with each of those wins



coming consecutively. Owned by James Miller, the daughter of JK Endofanera—Get Your Armor sports a bankroll of \$75,000. The \$13,000 yearling purchase at last fall's Hoosier Classic was bred by Brookview Farms.

Can'ttouchthese proved to be untouchable in the \$67,000 second division, teaming up with driver John De Long to score at odds of 1-2. De Long settled the favorite in the pocket position from post 3 while JK's Flirty Girl crossed over to take command of the field of six through a quarter of :27.1. The order remained unchanged on the backstretch with JK's Flirty Girl leading to the half in :56.4 before guiding the fillies to three-quarters in 1:26.1.

Turning for home, Can'ttouchthese popped the pocket and quickly grabbed command away from JK's Flirty Girl. Rocketing home in :26.2, Can'ttouchthese powered away by 3½ lengths to cruise to victory in a lifetime best of 1:52.4. JK's Flirty Girl held for the place position, with Tarshish (Brandon Bates) finishing third.

Roger Welch trains Can'ttouchthese who has won three of four to begin her career. The homebred daughter of JK Endofanera-Can't Touch This has banked \$56,770 for owners Douglas Riccolo and William and Patrick De Long.

MARTZ SEVEN, MIRACLE MAVEN MARVELOUS

A new week of racing at Harrah's Hoosier Park kicked-off with round three of Indiana Sire Stakes for rookie trotting fillies highlighting the 13-race card on Tuesday (Aug. 13). A pair of \$67,500 divisions saw **Martz Seven** and **Miracle Maven** each deliver victories with career best efforts.

Sent off as the 4-5 favorite in the first division, Martz Seven teamed up with regular pilot Mike Peterson from post 4 in the field of eight. The Walter Haynes, Jr. trainee left alertly from the gate, quickly crossing over to grab command at the quarter pole in :28.4. Fifty To Win (driven by Ricky Macomber, Jr.) continued her leave attempt first-over to grab command on the backstretch from Martz Seven before leading the fillies to the half in :58.4. Fifty To Win guided the field to three-quarters in 1:28.2 while Martz Seven stalked intently from the pocket.

Turning for home, Peterson angled Martz Seven off of the Macomber helmet before she quickly pulled alongside Fifty To Win, putting her nose in front with an eighth-of-a-mile to go. Sprinting home in :27, Martz Seven began to edge clear late

in the lane, motoring home $1\frac{1}{2}$ lengths clear on the wire in 1:55.4 over Fifty To Win. Sweetasmoni (Kyle Wilfong) finished in the show position.

Yet to miss the board in her young career, Martz Seven is now a two-time winner through six outings. The \$9,500 yearling purchase at the 2023 Hoosier Classic sports a career bankroll of \$75,067 for owners Black And White Stable and Stephen Stoll. The daughter of Swan For All—La Mirada was bred by Martz Creek Farm and Roman Stoll.

Henry Graber, Jr. trainees went one-two in the second and fastest division, with Miracle Maven and John De Long cruising past the favored Better Tak'em (Jordan Ross) in the stretch to earn the victory.

Leaving from the rail, De Long settled Miracle Maven in third early while Ponda Fashion (Kyle Wilfong) cleared from the far outside post 8 to take command at the quarter in a hot :27.1. Ponda Fashion cruised to the half in :56.1 with the Graber trainees in tow, Better Tak'em in the pocket and Miracle Maven sitting third. The lead trio trotted well clear of the remainder of the field on the final turn, with Ponda Fashion speeding to three-quarters in 1:25.3.

At the top of the stretch, Ponda Fashion came under a two-pronged attack with Better Tak'em to her outside and Miracle Maven skimming the pylons to her inside. Better Tak'em held secured a short-lived lead midway through the lane before Miracle Maven geared up a :27.2 rally up the rail to surge clear by 31/4 lengths over her stablemate in 1:53.3. Swan Jewel (Trace Tetrick) rallied for the third spot. Miracle Maven paid \$8 to win at the betting windows.

The 1:53.3 clocking took over three seconds off of her previous mark of 1:57 as Miracle Maven claimed her third victory in five career outings. Owned by Eleven Star Stables, Frank Baldachino, Beasty LLC and Hillside Stables, Miracle Maven now boasts a career bankroll of \$67,395. Noah Wickey bred the daughter of Don't Let'em—Bad Babysitter who was an \$8,500 yearling purchase at the 2023 Michiana Classic Yearling Sale.

The 1:53.3 clocking was just two-fifths of a second off of the 1:53.1 track record for 2-year-old trotting fillies established by R Melina in the 2023 Kentuckiana Stallion Management Stakes last September.

Richard Hans' homebred **Only I Exist** rolled to her seventh win in as many starts of her sophomore season with a 1:57 score in the \$46,000 Maryland Standardbred Race Fund (MSRF) for 3-year-old trotting fillies, held Wednesday (Aug. 14) at Ocean Downs.

Only I Exist and driver Russell Foster had no trouble clearing the lead from post 2, and the pair seated Going Platinum (driven by Corey Callahan) in the pocket on the first turn. The complexion of the race changed abruptly when 1-2 favorite Six Inch Heels, who yielded to the 3-hole from her pole position, broke stride entering the backstretch. This allowed Only I Exist to coast unopposed through splits of :28.4,:59.1 and 1:28 before using :29 closing speed to evade Going Platinum by 2½ lengths in 1:57.1 See A Star (Johnathan Ahle) narrowly collared the tiring FD Pure Platinum for third, 13¼ lengths farther behind.

Only I Exist, a daughter of Yall Beneath Me—Get Rich Quick who Hans also trains, paid \$9.80 to win as the 7-2 third choice. She now has won 13 of her 14 career races and banked over \$280,000.

Two \$26,500 MSRF splits for 3-year-old pacing fillies were also contested, with **Hurrikaneaphrodite** (\$2.10) and driver Corey Callahan evading Bridge Of Love in 1:56 for trainer John McDermott and the partnership of Jonathan Klee Racing, Justin Bolasci, Big George Stables and Hurrikane Racing in the first division; and **Silly Choice** (\$20.20) and driver William Carter defeating 1-20 favorite Leanne's Choice by two lengths in 1:55 for trainer Cory Mumford and owner Ezy Ranch. Winbak Farm bred both victorious pacing fillies.

Foster, Johnathan Ahle and Trae Porter all recorded driving doubles on the 11-race card.

Vivid Wise As pulls out of MGM Yonkers International Trot; Capital Mail takes his place

Vivid Wise As, the 2023 MGM Yonkers International Trot winner and first horse to receive an invitation to the exclusive \$1 million event at Yonkers Raceway, will not be able to defend his title and will be replaced by fellow Italian representative Capital Mail.

It was announced Tuesday (Aug. 13) that Vivid Wise As is sick and had lost weight, making it impossible for trainer Alessandro Gocciadoro to prepare the 10-year-old for the upcoming trip across the Atlantic Ocean for the Sept. 7 race.

While the absence of Vivid Wise As is not ideal, Capital Mail was quick to scoop up his invitation. The 6-year-old has an impressive résumé of his own, with just shy of one million Euros earned in his career and 16 wins from 49 starts. In early May, the son of Nad Al Sheba won Italy's most prestigious international race — the Gran Premio Lotteria at Agnano in Naples — and followed that up with a second-place finish in Elitloppet eliminations before finishing sixth in the final.

Capital Mail, who is trained by Gennaro Casillo for owner Saverio Cortese, joins Hail Mary in the field for the 2024 MGM Yonkers International Trot. More invitations are expected to be handed out in the coming days and will be announced shortly.

The MGM Yonkers International Trot will be the centerpiece of a spectacular afternoon card (12:15 p.m. EDT post time) on Sept. 7 that also features a pair of \$250,000 invitationals for older horses and the \$1.8 million finals of the New York Sire Stakes.

Eliminations set for Wellwood and Peaceful Way

Grand Circuit season at Woodbine Mohawk Park launches this Saturday night (Aug. 17) with the eliminations for the William Wellwood Memorial and Peaceful Way.

A pair of \$30,000 eliminations will be contested for each event, with 19 2-year-old trotting colts and geldings lining up in the

Wellwood and 14 rookie trotting fillies in the Peaceful Way. The top-five finishers from each elimination advance to the finals.

New Jersey Sires Stakes champion Nordic Catcher S headlines the Wellwood eliminations. The Ake Svanstedt trainee will compete in the second elimination (race 10), making his first start since a 1:53.3 score in the New Jersey final on Aug. 3.

A uniquely bred son of Six Pack, out of a Somebeachsomewhere mare, Nordic Catcher S has won two of three starts to begin his career. Svanstedt will handle the driving duties from post 2.

Nordic Catcher S will face the likes of the well-bred Emoticon Legacy (Louis-Philippe Roy, post 5), who is one-for-one, and You Got It Kempt (post 6, Sylvain Filion), who recently won the Ontario Sires Stakes Mid-Season Challenge.

The first Wellwood elimination includes Millard Farms Series winner Tregaron (post 3) for Team Young. The gelded son of Propulsion captured the Millard final in 1:55.2 for driver Scott Young and his father, Bob Young.

Extended Session (post 8, James MacDonald) will look to rebound after making a break in the Millard final and suffering his first loss in four starts. Marcus Melander trainee Maryland (post 4, Dexter Dunn) and Ron Burke student Tactical Dynasty (post 7, Yannick Gingras) are also expected to figure prominently in the first Wellwood split.

The William Wellwood Memorial eliminations are scheduled as races 8 and 10 on Saturday's 12-race card.

The first Peaceful Way elimination features the top-two locally trained rookie trotting fillies to this point in the season.

Blake MacIntosh trainee Monalishi (post 2, Jody Jamieson) has won three of four starts, including the OSS Mid-Season Challenge. The daughter of Green Manalishi S is riding a three-race win streak into Saturday.

Cantab Hall filly Lasting Dream (post 6, Roy) enters off a strong 1:54.1 victory in the Pure Ivory Series final for Determination and trainer Luc Blais. Lasting Dream has won two of four starts to date.

The second Peaceful Way division will have all eyes on New Jersey Sires Stakes champion Champagne Problems for trainer Nancy Takter. The daughter of Tactical Landing posted a dazzling 1:52.3 victory over a sloppy track on Aug. 3 at The Meadowlands. A winner of three of four starts, Champagne Problems teams with Dexter Dunn from post 6.

The Peaceful Way eliminations are carded as races 3 and 7.

The William Wellwood Memorial and Peaceful Way finals will take place on Saturday (Aug. 24). Elimination winners will secure a post position from 2 to 6 for the final.

A full field of eight 4-year-old pacers will compete Sunday (Aug. 18) at the Hippodrome 3R (H3R) in Trois-Rivieres, QC in the return of the Prix d'Ete Grand Circuit race with a purse of \$200,000.

A total of 10 horses were entered in the prestigious stakes event that was last held at H3R in 2019. The stakes condition states that the top eight 2024 money winners get into the race. The remaining two are the also eligibles.

It's My Show is the class of the field and a career winner of \$1.256 million. The royally bred son of Sweet Lou—Put On A Show last year won the Little Brown Jug and the North America Cup. In his last start he was second by a neck in the \$220,000 Sam McKee Memorial at The Meadowlands in 1:47.3.

Act Fast (Downbytheseaside) entered the Prix d'Ete off the fastest mile of his career last week, winning the \$100,000 Myron Charna President's Pace at Northfield Park's half mile oval in 1:50.2. It was his fourth win on the year for the Ron Burke Stable, who has also entered Tip Top Cat (Always B Miki), a 1:50.4 winner this season.

Light The Torch (Always B Miki) is the local favorite, having raced and won numerous times at H3R for trainer Marc-Andre Simoneau and has a record this year of 1:53.2 at Rideau Carleton.

Once the premier race in all of Canada, the Prix d'Ete (Summer Prize) was originally for 3-year-old pacers and would feature the best colts in North America year after year. Previous winners included Bret Hanover, Albatross, Niatross, Hot Hitter, Cam Fella, On The Road Again, Ralph Hanover, Matt's Scooter and a host of other top pacers.

The Prix d'Ete was last held at the Hippodrome 3R in 2019 when This Is The Plan and driver Daniel Dube set the all-time track and stakes record and Canadian record (half-mile track) of 1:49.1.

The Prix D'Ete will be held as the 10th race on the 12-race Sunday card that begins at noon. Also on the program will be the third leg of the Future Stars Series for Quebec-bred 2-year-old pacing colts and fillies. There will be two divisions for the colts and one for the fillies.

The sale continues Tuesday through Thursday with afternoon sessions beginning at 1 p.m., then concludes Friday, Oct. 4, with that final session getting underway at 7 p.m.
