Bythemissal is the one to beat in the Max Hempt

This, and other Sun Stakes Saturday observations.

In the period of less than one month, Bythemissal (Downbytheseaside) has gone from a near total unknown to being the likely slight favorite over the Meadowlands Pace and Cane Pace winner Beach Glass when those two hook up Saturday (Aug. 20) in the \$300,00 Max Hempt Memorial as part of the Sun Stakes Saturday card at Pocono Downs. Fresh off his smashing 1:48.4 world record tying performance by a 3-year-old gelding last Saturday at Northfield Park in the Carl Milstein Memorial, the Hempt will be a rematch of the top two from Adios three weeks ago.

The rise of Bythemissal has been meteoric considering what he's done in such a short time, but it's not by luck he's this good. In contrast to last year's 3-year-old star out of Ohio, Charlie May, who had just a modest pedigree, the Ohio-sired Bythemissal was a relatively pricey yearling, going for \$135,000 at the 2020 Lexington Selected Sale. The first foal out of his dam, Dismissal, his second dam Her Mattjesty has produced seven foals who earned over \$100,000. Her Mattjesty herself was a talented young filly who earned almost \$400,000 in her career and going back to Bythemissal's third dam is Lady Hathaway, producer of world champion Royal Mattjesty and 2-year-old O'Brien winner His Mattjesty.

Purchased from that sale by Josh Green who also trained the horse in his first lifetime start for owner Eric Good, Bythemissal debuted last November at Dover Downs in a race where he came from well off the pace and drew away impressively. Earlier this year, an opportunity arose where additional owners including Burke Racing Stable, Rich Lombardo and Weaver Bruscemi came to buy into the horse, with Good still retaining primary share.



Year's Fastest 2YO Trotter

The dual eligible, Brittany-bred **Special Way** (above) became the year's fastest 2-year-old trotter with her 1:52.2 win in the \$80,000 KYSS Championship Series at the Red Mile. As co-owner Mark Weaver said, "Ronnie (Burke) didn't even start training him until earlier this year around February or so, we ended up buying into a part of him, and as long as we've had him Ronnie thought he was going to be pretty good."

Bythemissal was sensational in winning the Adios, coming first over from way back to beat Beach Glass.

"We really were confident that we could go with Beach Glass and Pebble Beach," said Weaver. "He had won his first five races and did it quite impressively, but then the way his schedule worked out, he didn't have a race for about six weeks. His Adios elimination was his first real start in a month and a half, and he was a very comfortable second after being a long way back, so we felt that he had a pretty big shot in the final.

"He actually doesn't have that great of a stakes schedule, it's kind of a 'B' or 'B-minus' schedule. But we were lucky that the Milstein was an invite and he did have both the Adios and the Hempt, which are two really good ones to go with the outstanding Ohio program."

This is the first year in which any horse can supplement to the Little Brown Jug, and Weaver noted that option is on the table.

"If it were tomorrow, I think we would supplement to the Jug, but Eric Good is the main owner. If it's up to me, we're not afraid to put up money for the Jug so we're certainly game to do that, as well as the Breeders Crown later in the year if we think that makes sense."

While the Hempt would seem to come down to Bythemissal and Beach Glass from posts three and one respectively, Mad Max Hanover could be lurking. He was a game second to Beach Glass last out in the Cane, was a 1:47.4 winner two back, and was ultra-sharp the last two times he raced at Pocono back in May. The Max Hempt Memorial goes as race 11 on the card.

\$300,000 EARL BEAL MEMORIAL RACE 12


The co-richest race on the day is for the 3-year-old trotters, and the Beal will mark the first race for the Hambletonian hero Cool Papa Bell since his massive upset two weeks ago. Credit the horse, of course, but enough can't be said for the job Todd McCarthy did as well in engineering that upset. Saving all the ground to sneak up the inside to third, he neatly angled out at the top of the stretch, kept his trotter together when it appeared he was close to breaking, and capitalized in a race where the top contenders weren't at their best despite cushy fractions. Can he be that good again?

Cool Papa Bell lands the role of 5-2 favorite on the morning line but it seems possible that the post-time favorite may end up being Temporal Hanover. Orjan Kihlstrom gave him a chance in the Hambletonian but he couldn't quite sustain the tough trip all the way, same as in his elimination. It's back to Sears now and the last time these two were together was a 1:50 mile in the Dancer.

Periculum wasn't far off either in the Hambletonian at odds of over 100-1. He's a consistent type for Melander. I thought Pretender was one of the more serious Hambletonian contenders earlier in the year when he swept through the New Jersey Sires Stakes, including a final win over both Temporal Hanover and Periculum. He hasn't been bad since; just needs to pick it up

Just as in the Hempt, posts one and three would seem to have this race cornered, between Joviality and Jiggy Jog. These two fillies would remain formidable even if they were still in against the colts, and this race could simply come down to the trip. While Joviality has rightfully gotten most of the attention this year, Jiggy Jog has been just as good as late. She surged for the win in her Hambletonian elimination two back and then had to come widest of everyone last week and was still making up ground. Joviality had room to the inside of Rebuff and got second in that race; I still think the track was playing unusual that day. Delilah Hanover is an intriguing possibility; has come close to beating the best fillies on more than one occasion this year and you could do worse than Todd McCarthy and Nifty. Pink Poco Chanel outraced in her last two; obviously the fillies in those non-winners of two races were more difficult than they look.

First-year conditioner Amy Husted on the cusp of Hawthorne trainer title

The wife of driver Kyle Husted has a slim lead on perennial Illinois champion Terry Leonard.

With a month remaining in the second and last of the year's two meetings at Hawthorne Race Course, first-year trainer Amy Husted is clinging to the lead in the trainer standings.

Going into tonight's (Aug. 19) resumption of racing at Hawthorne, the 27-year-old wife of driver Kyle Husted has 18 winners, one more than perennial defending champion Terry Leonard.

Since moving to the Midwest to be with Kyle five years ago, Amy had been working with him at the barn while he was the trainer of record.

"That was the only way I could get her the recognition she deserves," Kyle said, explaining why she is now listed as the trainer. "She's there at the barn every day training them. She does it all and I just help her. We still make decisions together but she's the boss."

Heredity and environment laid the foundation for Amy's immediate success.

She was born in Vernon, NY, where her parents raced horses. Her father, Jimmy Cruise, is a retired driver/trainer and her mother, Robin Cruise, is training horses for Carter Pinske at The Red Mile.

"My parents got divorced when I was about 8 years old," Amy said. "My dad continued to go to Vernon Downs, while my mom started working for Erv Miller and I would spend my summers in New Jersey

with her. I started jogging horses for Erv when I was about 14. I (later) worked for Erv and then for Tony Alagna for a while."

Alagna currently ranks No. 1 among North American trainers in purses earned and Miller ranks No. 3 so it's safe to say that some of their expertise has rubbed off on Amy.

There's also the genetic factor.

"My mom is a Farrington," Amy said. "My grandpa, Frank Farrington, trained a lot of good horses and my uncle, Bob Farrington, had the great Rambling Willie. My uncle is in the Hall of Fame and so is my grandpa on dad's side, Jimmy Cruise, Sr. I guess you could say that I have a good pedigree on both sides."

Amy and Kyle met at a Halloween Party in New Jersey. He also has racing roots and a stint working under a world class trainer on his resume.

Kyle, who will turn 31 in September, comes from the small town of Altamont in southern Illinois. His mother, Pam Coleman, was a trainer and so were his grandfather and great grandfather.

"My mom raced a few horses in Chicago that I jogged," he said. "I drove in my first race when I was 15 or 16. I worked my way up from the amateurs to the Illinois county fairs, to the pari-mutuel tracks, to having winners on Hawthorne's Night of Champions.





"The January after I turned 18, I came to Chicago and raced at Balmoral and Maywood. I went to Prairie Meadows in Iowa with my provisional license and won my first race.

"After Balmoral and Maywood closed I went east and worked for Nancy Takter (North America's 2020 Trainer of the Year) and Nifty Norman for a while." He and Amy started dating after they met at the Halloween party and she followed him when he returned to Chicago racing to train and drive at Hawthorne. They married in 2021 and she gave birth to their daughter, Emma, in November.

"We only had about three horses when we first got together," she said. "Kyle was mostly catch-driving.

"David Brigham (from Litchfield, MI) was the first owner to trust us and buy us babies and then we had others come to us. John Schwarz (from Wood Dale, IL) is another of our big owners and so is Michael Brenczweski (from Plainfield, IL). Michael's father owned horses with our uncle Bob but none of us had any idea until we owned horses together. We couldn't be successful without great owners supporting us."

The first yearling the Husteds bought with Brigham was Fox Valley Exploit and the 5-year-old mare is the best horse in their stable. On the Night of Champions she has won the Incredible Tillie at age 2, the Plum Peachy at 3 and the Tony Maurello at 4. Those triumphs put her in the distinguished company of Fox Valley Gemini as one of only two horses with undefeated records in three or more starts on the Night of Champions.

Indicative of Fox Valley Exploit's class, after the Hawthorne meeting the Husteds sent the Illinois-bred daughter of Sportsmaster and She Likes It All to the Meadowlands where she earned \$35,875 in 10 starts.

Amy and Kyle have 18 horses at Hawthorne and six at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing and Casino and on Monday they added to their stable by buying eight Illinois-bred Yearlings at the Land of Lincoln Sale.

"Amy has a few nice 2-year-olds and a 3-year-old who are starting to blossom," said veteran Hawthorne track announcer Peter Galassi.

He cited the 3-year-old pacer Get E Up, who has a lifetime mark of 1:51.2; the 2-year-old male trotter Niko Man, a winner last week at the State Fair in Springfield in 1:55; the 2-year-old filly trotter Fox Valley Candor, who broke her maiden last Friday at Springfield; and Fox Valley Landen, a 2-year-old gelding pacer with two wins and three places in his first six races.

The performances of the Illinois-breds trained by Amy suggest another big Night of Champions might be in the offing for Kyle, who in 2018 was a catch-drive winner of two of the races for trainer Steve Searle and another for trainer Harold Guerra.

"Amy not only is good with Illinois-breds, she's good with claimers, too," Galassi said. "She claimed an older male pacer Sunny and Eighty and he won first time off the claim and a My grandpa, Frank Farrington, trained a lot of good horses and my uncle, Bob Farrington, had the great Rambling Willie. 9-year-old gelding pacer Star of Oz, who won a conditioned race at Hawthorne on Sunday night."

According to Kyle, getting involved with claimers was a "culture shock" for Amy.

"I grew up with claimers, while she never had taken care of a claimer or trained a claimer until we got together," he said. "She was well aware of the claiming game but she was in shock the time we lost the first one. The look on her face when she realized the horse wouldn't come home with her was priceless."

Amy has strong emotional ties binding her to two of the horses in her barn — stable star Fox Valley Exploit and a 9-year-old gelding pacer named Dash of Danger.

"We've had Dash of Danger for about five years," she said. "He's just a consistent old warhorse. Last year, he broke a sesamoid

and had to have surgery. Sunday night at Hawthorne he made his first start in a year. He drew the rail and Kyle just wanted him to have an easy race but he ran through a hole that didn't exist to win and then he had his number taken down for causing interference and was placed fifth."

The Husteds will be headed to Hoosier Park after the Hawthorne meeting ends on Sept. 11, but are undecided on where they'll go for winter racing.

"The last two winters we went to Florida but now it's uncertain," Amy said. "We just bought a house in Anderson, Indiana. We've had to branch out and start a small stable at Hoosier so we have a place to race when Hawthorne is closed.

"We would love to race full-time in Illinois, but it's just so hard (to base here) because of the racing schedule."

FINISH LINES

The closing of Balmoral Park and Maywood Park in 2015 followed by the 2021 closing of the Midwest's premier thoroughbred track, the historic and palatial Arlington International Racecourse by corporate owner Churchill Downs, Inc., made Hawthorne the only track in the Chicago market to accommodate both breeds.

As a consequence, this year began with a Jan. 7-March 20 harness meeting followed by a thoroughbred meeting. The standardbreds went back to the track on June 30 for the current meeting. After the meeting ends thoroughbred racing will resume on Sept. 22 and continue through Dec. 31.

To minimize the damaged created by the time-share situation, the Illinois Harness Horsemen's Association, Hawthorne and the Illinois Department of Agriculture made arrangements to bookend the current meeting with races at the Springfield State Fairgrounds on June 17, 18, 24 and 25, Sept. 16, 17, 23, 24 and 30 and Oct. 1.


The annual races at the State Fairs in Springfield and DuQuoin also have taken on added importance. Springfield scheduled races for last week on Friday and Saturday and this week for Wednesday and Thursday. DuQuoin will race Aug. 26 and 27.

For drivers and trainers, the status quo makes for a lot of time on the road. Springfield is about a 190 mile drive from Hawthorne, while DuQuoin is a trip of approximately 325 miles.

Hirt so good

The Clyde Hirt Journalism Workshop pays tribute to the Hall of Fame writer by sharing harness racing with a new generation.

The workshop, currently co-chaired by Ken Weingartner and myself, was founded in 2003 and is now focused on writing, although TV and photojournalists do attend.

In 2005, Michael Casagrande, a young journalist at Western Kentucky University, was a workshop attendee.

"The workshop gave me the confidence to step outside my comfort zone and cover a sport I had only seen a few times in passing," said Casagrande. "Starting from scratch meant learning harness racing from the ground level to the point I could write for an audience who'd know if I didn't do my homework.

"Some of the connections I made at the workshop helped build my career through freelance assignments and job references. It's been 17 years since I participated and I'm still in touch with a few of the professionals I met that week."

Amanda Stellwag, a rising junior at Rutgers University, majoring in journalism and media studies, knew nothing about harness racing but all that quickly changed.



"My experience from the workshop was amazing, a great learning experience, and a chance to see how being a part of a journalism team works," said Stellwag. "I was able to get experience writing articles for a professional newspaper and make connections while visiting the places I was taken to during the workshop. I also gained knowledge about harness racing history, the terminology, and a real hands-on lesson on how to ride in a jog cart."

Unlike the overwhelming majority of workshop attendees, University of Kentucky student Emily Gaskin – Hirt class of 2009 – grew up in a harness racing family.

"The Clyde Hirt workshop played a pivotal role in the shaping of my career — it provided much needed experience and maybe even more importantly, allowed me to gain confidence in my writing skills when I needed it most," said Gaskin. "After my time with the workshop, I was inspired to continue to pursue my career goals within the industry. The hands-on learning experience, the working relationships I was able to cultivate and the opportunity to learn from some of the best media professionals within the industry — all while having a good time doing it — was something I'll never forget, and I am so thankful I had the opportunity to attend."

None of this year's class had ever heard of harness racing – let alone seen it live – before.

Claudine Smith, a rising senior at Rutgers University and want-to-be sideline reporter, made suggestions on how the workshop's TV student could be posting live interviews for social media, which will be adopted moving forward.

"My experience as a Clyde Hirt Journalism Workshop student is one I will never forget," said Smith. "I was exposed to so many opportunities that I would not have gotten anywhere else. My favorite part of the workshop was meeting different people in the journalism field who were so open and willing to give advice and help me in any way they can.

"I was also very enthused that I got the chance to interview a Giants' football player because one of my favorite things about being a journalist is asking questions and talking to people to know their story."

La Salle University student Amanda Johncola did the workshop in 2015, splitting her time between writing and photography.

"Even though the Clyde Hirt Workshop focuses on live-event writing, it's helped me in all of the jobs I've had since then," said Johncola. "When I was in the workshop, I thought I was going to have a long-lived journalism career. I'm no longer in journalism, but for the few years that I was, it really helped me hone my writing skills.

"The fast paced objective of writing a live sporting event helped me to write breaking news. It taught me to gather the facts quickly and how to write concisely to get a piece out as quickly as possible. It also taught me how to focus on the main topic and not to be distracted by background noise."

Johncola returned to the workshop in 2016 as a photographer before graduating and becoming a Hirt advisor in 2017.

"The skills I learned helped me, even in what I do today as a 911 dispatcher," said Johncola. "The fast-paced atmosphere of a race helped me to remain calm in gathering information in an emergency. The interview skills I learned also helped me figuring out what information is necessary to get for police to get them vital information as quickly as possible.

"In all, the skills taught by the advisors at the Clyde Hirt workshop extend far beyond journalism. I wouldn't have made it where I am today without those skills."

This workshop would not be possible without advisors Garnet and Nick Barnsdale, Lia Eustachewich, Dave Little and Kelly Young, as well as *Trentonian* sports editor Kyle Franko, *Boston Globe* sports editor Matt Pepin, *DRF Harness* editor Derick Giwner, Edison Hatter, Pat Leonard, Curtis MacDonald, Kristin Roberts and Tara Sullivan. With special thanks to everyone at The Meadowlands, Ray Schnittker, the New York Football Giants, the Harness Racing Museum, the *New York Post*, the Ohio Chapter of USHWA, The Hambletonian Society and the USTA.

Megan Husslein, a rising junior at The Ohio State University, was chosen to attend the workshop by the Ohio chapter of USHWA, who sponsored her.

"Coming into the Clyde Hirt Journalism Workshop, I knew nothing about the sport of harness racing. Additionally, that's all I expected the workshop to be about. However, I was pleasantly surprised about the range of events that we got to partake in. From attending Giants training camp, to visiting the *New York Post* and even jogging a horse, it was a week full of unforgettable memories. This workshop gave me opportunities that I otherwise would have never received, and for that I am so thankful.

"As for the harness racing aspect, Debbie, Garnet and Nick were great teachers who were very patient with all of our questions. They helped us realize how fun this sport can be and I can now officially say that I am hooked! They, along with Ken Weingartner, helped me write two stories that were published in the *Trentonian*, and one of them was published in print — my first one ever. Overall, I am so happy that I took a chance and attended this journalism workshop — strangers became family, lifelong memories were made and harness racing gained a new fan!"





World record performance by San Moteur

Björn Goop-trained 5-year-old **San Moteur** (Panne de Moteur) impressed many when he won the \$295,000 Jubileumspokalen at Solvalla on Wednesday (Aug. 17) night. Over a distance of 2,140 meters and starting from post 10 on a hot summer night in Stockholm, Goop managed to hit a position in second over with San Moteur, the bettors' first choice.

With Mister Hercules in the lead after the first 500 meters, first over trotter Önas Prince was given orders to attack the leader with 3/4 of a mile to go, a move that set the pace high when the field reached the first kilometer. Önas Prince didn't get much out of the attempt and Goop was quick minded as he sent San Moteur to position outside the leader as the field turned in to the last kilometer.

San Moteur put hard pressure on Mister Hercules throughout the last turn and the leader was beaten with 300 meters to go. The other horses were never close to challenge the flying San Moteur at the stretch and as he hit the wire, he did it in a new world record mark over 2.140 meters -1:52.1.

Global Badman followed in second after a pocket trip and Chiru finished strongly in third. This was Goop's second Group 1 victory in five days.

Last Saturday, he claimed Åby Stora Pris with Moni Viking and in San Moteur he definitely has a horse that can challenge any other horse in the world, probably over any distance as well. It's a fact that the entourage around the horse have received an invitation, or at least some kind of request from Yonkers Raceway, regarding a participation in the \$1 million International Trot on Oct. 15. San Moteur might be the Swedish participant in that specific race, but Goop and the owner Håkan Arvidsson have been quite cautious with the horse so far in the 5-year-old trotter's career. In May this year, they declined an invitation to Elitloppet, but who knows? The International Trot is prestigious and San Moteur would make a strong contribution to the race.

HONEY MEARAS BEST IN EUROPE

Five-year-old **Honey Mearas** (Readly Express) dominated the crop among the mares as a 4-year-old and on Wednesday night she claimed the title in the \$195,000 European Championship for mares over 1.3 miles at Solvalla.

Honey Mearas had to do the heavy job three wide during the races last half mile and in her back, strong finishers like Sayonara and Zeudi Amg followed in the last turn. When the front runners



were out of gas at the top of the stretch, Honey Mearas got advantage of the race, but behind her Sayonara attacked and seemed to catch the trophy. But Honey Mearas wanted something else and she fought back when Örjan Kihlström asked for it at mid-stretch. Sayonara never got seriously close as the wire approached and Honey Mearas won in mile rate 1:53.3.

Sayonara was second and Zeudi Amg third.

UPSET WINNER ENDED ENGHIEN'S SUMMER MEETING

Paris track Enghien ended its summer meeting on Wednesday (Aug. 17) afternoon and in the \$152,500 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere some well-known trotters were in the field. Prix d'Amérique runner-up Galius and Harper Hanover's race winner Diable de Vauvert were two of the bettors' favorites and the two horses were seen in front of the race until a kilometer remained of the race.

Delfino (Speedy Blue) attacked three wide from third over at that point and first over trotter Diable de Vauvert couldn't defend himself when Matthieu Mottier sent Delfino towards the leader Galius. Delfino disarmed the leader at the stretch and held on to safe win in mile rate 1:56.4 over 1.7 miles. Cash du Rib and Elie de Beaufour took the places behind the winner.

DELAYED FINAL TO VINCERO' GAR

The \$120,000 Gran Premio Citta' di Montecatini was scheduled on Monday (Aug. 15) night and two eliminations were held before heavy rain in the area forced the organizers to cancel the final.

Goop's Diamanten (Adrian Chip) and Alessandro Gocciadoro's Vernissage Grif (Varenne) won the eliminations, respectively, and the track officers in Montecatini decided to race the final on Tuesday (Aug. 16) night.

Diamanten and Vernissage Grif were the horses that kept the pace up high in the race but outside trotter Vernissage Grif couldn't challenge for the win as he ran out of power in the



last turn on the half-mile track. Second over **Vincero' Gar**, driven by Pietro Gubellini, attacked three wide in the last turn and the S.J.'s Photo son sprinted to safe win in 1:54.3.

Cokstile finished strongly as the runner up ahead of leader Diamanten.







Caretaker Emelia Jacobson on her unusual route into standardbred racing

It was, of all things, a haircut that brought Emelia Jacobson to horse racing.

The horsewoman from Wyoming, MN, lets out a big laugh before she starts the story, the tale of how she became involved in standardbred racing.

"I would say the way I got started in racing is pretty unconventional," said Jacobson, who now calls Humboldt, IA, home. "I've loved horses my entire life and my dad did a lot of farming when I was growing up. So, I would go out with him and see whatever horses I could see. A couple of years ago, my mom,

who is a cosmetologist, started cutting [driver/trainer] Brady Jenson's hair. Eventually, they started talking and he mentioned that he needed help one summer, so here I am. I've been working as a groom for the Jensons for about three years now."

For Jacobson, it's a job that certainly never feels like one.

It didn't take long for her to make strong connections with the band of horses she takes care of.

"There is no horse that is like another. They all have their different personalities, quirks and tendencies. And they all have something they can teach you."

Jacobson was immediately drawn to a now 6-year-old pacer by the name of Officer Jim. couple of seconds before the wire. You don't think or feel anything else going on... you just zone in on the race. I'm pretty quiet, and I just take it all in. Everything around me seems to stop until you figure out how the race will turn out.

Bred by Winbak Farm (Maryland), the son of American Ideal—Freedom Crossing was a \$70,000 purchase at the 2017 Harrisburg Sale.

After a third to launch his career on May 18 at Running Aces, the gelding broke his maiden next time out, one week later at the Minnesota oval.

"We don't have him anymore, but he was a goofball, a real character. He always wanted to know what you were doing. Horses that get your attention like that, they just suck you into it, and put a smile on your face every day. These horses are

happy to see you every morning. You could have had a bad night or a tough start to the day, but when you see their faces, and see how excited they are to see you, that changes everything."

Long hours and little time for other pursuits hasn't diminished Jacobson's enthusiasm for the sport.

"Everyone has good days and bad days, but a bad day in the barn is better than anywhere else. I'd rather be here than a lot of places. To be able to hang out with these beautiful animals, to make a connection with them, to see them progress, it's a wonderful thing. It's definitely a lot of work and it can be tiring, but you need to be dedicated to do it."

Watching the horses she grooms compete can be stressful at times, but

Jacobson somehow manages to internalize her nerves when she's at the rail.

Although she isn't outwardly vocal at those moments, she's inwardly effusive.

"I stop breathing those last couple of seconds before the wire. You don't think or feel anything else going on... you just zone in on the race. I'm pretty quiet, and I just take it all in. Everything around me seems to stop until you figure out how the race will turn out."

Jacobson strikes up a conversation with all her horses on the way back to the paddock.

Win or lose, pep talks dominate the one-way chats.

"I think they know when they've won. As a groom, especially, I'm the one that takes care of them after the race. I can get that read off their energy and see it in their eyes. Regardless of whether they win or lose, they always give their heart out there, so you just let them know how proud you are and give them a few pats."

As for the best part of her job, Jacobson points to two of racing's most notable groups.

"I would say it's the people and the horses I work with. Working for the Jensons, which is Brandon, Brady, his girlfriend Stephanie O'Connell, and Larry – we call it Team Jenson – they are just such great people and great people to be around. They're always happy for you to be there and to give you a chance, and to answer any question I've ever had. I got really lucky to get started with them. I if I hadn't started with them, I don't know if I would love it as much as I do. And then there are horses. To be able to have that bond with them is the best feeling you could have."

The biggest challenge is keeping pace with the busy life of a groom.



"I would say the toughest part is just how tired you are. It's a lot of work, but you have to remind yourself every day you wake up that this is what you want to do, and you have to put in the time and effort. But there hasn't been a day in my life that I've regretted doing this."

On the occasions she does get some free time, Jacobson can be found in front of a canvas, drawing and painting.

When she's not creating a work of art, she'll head outdoors to indulge in another favorite pastime.

"I like to go trap shooting. I did a lot of that in high school. It's been a while since I've done it, but it's a great way to unwind. But I'm happy when I'm in the barn too."

Or on the road.

One treasured part of Jacobson's job has been the chance to see more of the U.S. Seeing new sights, meeting new people, and racing at different venues has been a life-changing experience.

"I went to The Meadows with Brady. I'm originally from Minnesota, and that's all I've ever really seen, the Midwest landscape. So, being able to go to The Meadows was really awesome. I got to see a lot of cool things. And now for the summer, I'm down in Iowa, doing more of the fair circuit with Brandon. That's really different too. I think it's really cool to see different parts of the sport."

And to think she owes all of it to a pair of scissors and a razor. Which is a great story in itself, one that is, pardon the pun, a cut above those of her contemporaries.





Cool Papa Bell set for return in Beal

After registering the biggest upset in Hambletonian history two weeks ago, Cool Papa Bell will head to Saturday's (Aug. 20) \$300,000 Earl Beal Jr. Memorial at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono at the other end of the spectrum — as morning-line favorite.

Cool Papa Bell captured the Hambletonian at odds of 52-1 on Aug. 6 at The Meadowlands, giving trainer Jim Campbell the distinction of authoring the most unexpected results in both Hambletonian and Breeders Crown history. In 2020 at Harrah's Hoosier Park, Sandbetweenmytoes won the Crown for 3-year-old male pacers by a neck over future Horse of the Year Tall Dark Stranger at event-record odds of 203-1.

Both winners were near the rear of their fields at the halfway point in the mile — Cool Papa Bell in eighth and Sandbetweenmytoes in ninth — but stormed home in the stretch to triumph in the final strides.

"The thing with both those horses is that everything had to go right," Campbell said. "They had to get lucky with their trips. With Sandbetweenmytoes, he never really came into the (television) screen until the last couple steps. I had no idea whether he won, or whether he was fifth or sixth, they were all across the track.

"It was the same thing with Cool Papa Bell. We kept saying he gives us a good effort, but everything has to go his way. It did,

and he took advantage of it too. He put in his race. When he got clearance, he put his head down and dug in and trotted right through the wire.

"He accomplished the one thing that everybody who races a 3-year-old trotter wants to do. I hope he continues to have a good year the rest of the year, but he came up big on the right day."

On Saturday, Cool Papa Bell will look to make Hambletonian winners 2-for-2 in the Beal. Last year was the first time in the race's 10-year history that it followed the Hambletonian, and Hambletonian champ Captain Corey brought home the trophy from Pocono.

Cool Papa Bell will start from post one with Todd McCarthy in the sulky for Campbell and owner Scott Farber's Runthetable Stables. He is 5-2 on the morning line.

"He came out of the Hambo real good," said Campbell, who won the Beal in 2018 with Crystal Fashion. "Everything seems good with him."

A son of Chapter Seven—Blk Thai Optional, Cool Papa Bell has hit the board in seven of eight races this season, winning four and earning \$627,225. For his career, he has seven victories, four seconds and three thirds in 17 starts, good for \$760,999.

"He's just been a real nice horse to be around," Campbell said. "Even last year, when we raced him in the New York Sire Stakes, I would say he's like shipping around an old racehorse. Nothing really bothers him. He knows what he's got to do. If he does get his type of trip, he's always been there for us. He's got a good attitude and a great burst of speed."

Temporal Hanover, who was beaten by three-quarters of a length in finishing third in the Hambletonian, is the Beal's 3-1 second choice. Justice, coming off a win in a division of the Muscle Hill Trot on Hambletonian Day, is 4-1.

The Earl Beal Jr. Memorial, which honors the former president of the Pennsylvania Harness Horsemen's Association who helped bring casino gaming to the state's racetracks, is part of a Sun Stakes Saturday card at Pocono that includes the \$300,000 Max C. Hempt Memorial for 3-year-old male pacers, \$250,000 James M. Lynch Memorial for 3-year-old female pacers, and the \$250,000 Delmonica Hanover for 3-year-old female trotters.

In the Hempt, Adios and Carl Milstein Memorial winner Bythemissal is the 5-2 choice over Meadowlands Pace and Cane Pace winner Beach Glass at 3-1. In the Lynch, Max Contract, the winner of four in a row including the Mistletoe Shalee, Tompkins-Geers, and Shady Daisy, is the 5-2 favorite.

Hambletonian runner-up Joviality S is the 5-2 favorite in the Delmonica Hanover, with Hambletonian fourth-place finisher Jiggy Jog S next at 3-1.

Brown can count on Trick Of The Light

When it comes to providing full effort, trainer Brian Brown sees nothing deceptive about Trick Of The Light. She gives her best time after time.

Trick Of The Light was an Indiana Sire Stakes champion last year and heads to Saturday's (Aug. 20) \$250,000 James M. Lynch Memorial for 3-year-old female pacers at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono with 13 finishes no worse than second in 18 lifetime starts, winning eight.

The daughter of Odds On Equuleus—Gordjus enters the Lynch off back-to-back victories, most recently on Aug. 13 as the only filly taking on mares in the Fillies & Mares Open 2/Open 3 at Harrah's Hoosier Park. The race's second-place finisher, Mystical Carrie, won twice in the preliminary rounds of the Blue Chip Matchmaker Series earlier this season.

"She's not really gone a bad race," Brown said about Trick Of The Light. "She's always trying her heart out. Even when she's tied up a hair once in a while, never usually bad but maybe enough that she doesn't get all the way to the wire, she is still trying

all the way. She's just a good horse. These are the ones you can count on every week."

Trick Of The Light will begin the Lynch from post two in a field of eight with Dexter Dunn in the sulky. She is 4-1 on the morning line.

Max Contract, the winner of four in a row including the Mistletoe Shalee, Tompkins-Geers, and Shady Daisy, is the 5-2 favorite. Captain Cowgirl, a three-time winner this season in the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes, is the 3-1 second choice. The field also includes Adioo Volo winner Sweet Kisses (9-2) and Fan Hanover Stakes champ Treacherous Dragon (6-1).

"There are good fillies in there, so (Trick Of The Light) will have to be at the top of her game," Brown said. "I think she will hold her own, that's for sure. We got a good post, so we should be okay."

This will be Trick Of The Light's third appearance in a Grand Circuit event. She was second in the Nadia Lobell Stakes, beaten a neck by Boudoir Hanover, and fourth in the Mistletoe Shalee, beaten by 1-3/4 lengths after a first-over move around the final turn. Post-race testing revealed she had slight muscle cramping.

"That was a really good race," Brown said about the Mistletoe Shalee. "She's got the desire to be a good horse. I think she pretty much has it all. She's a great-looking filly — not real tall but strong, long barreled, and great gaited. She has ability, she's got guts. She has everything you could want in a horse."

Trick Of The Light was a \$50,000 purchase under the name Lady Bellatrix at the 2020 Hoosier Classic Yearling Sale. She has earned \$362,150 lifetime for owners Country Club Acres, Joe Sbrocco, and Kirk Nichols.



She is well staked the remainder of the season, including the Jugette at Brown's home track at the Delaware County Fairgrounds in Ohio.

"I'm looking forward to racing her in the Jugette because she does get around Delaware," said Brown, who is based at the fairgrounds. "She's got gate speed; I think she will be really good."

A Real Legend sets world record In Ohio Sires Stakes

A Real Legend put together a legendary performance in just his fifth start of his career as he set a new world record in the Ohio Sires Stakes at MGM Northfield Park on Monday night (Aug. 15).

In the second of two \$55,000 divisions for freshman colt trotters, John Dutton and Chris Page raced to the early lead covering the first quarter in :29.2.

Just past the quarter pole, A Real Legend with Don Irvine Jr. grabbed the front end and never looked back. The son of Uncle Peter covered the second quarter in :28, hitting the half-mile pole in :57.2.

A Real Legend extend the lead to two-lengths at the top of the stretch and held off John Dutton tripping the wire in 1:55 to win by a length.

The clocking set a new track record and world record for 2-year-old gelded trotters on a half-mile track. Owned by trainer Rosy Weaver and Heartland Acres, A Real Legend has now earned \$75,300.

John Dutton finished second with Black Magic third.

In the first division, **Jet Hill**, the 1-9 favorite with Kurt Sugg, made it look easy, going gate-to-wire winning in 1:57.

Sugg took the son of What The Hill to lead and cut the mile with fractions of :29.1, :59.1 and 1:27.4. The win was the second for Jet Hill in four starts with both wins coming in the Ohio Sires Stakes.

Jet Hill is trained by Edward Miller and owned by Serenity Racing Stables. With the win, Jet Hill has earned \$59,375 this year.

Burton's Hill was second with Asian Zing finishing third.

Ohio Sires Stakes action resumes this afternoon (Aug. 19) at Eldorado Scioto Downs with the third leg for 2-year-old filly pacers. First race post time is 3:15 p.m.





Dancing double in OSS Gold at Grand River

Ontario's top 2-year-old pacing fillies travelled to Grand River Raceway on Wednesday (Aug. 17) for a pair of \$102,200 Ontario Sires Stakes Gold divisions.

OSS action began in race four with **Starlight Dancer** emerging victorious from the eight-horse field.

When the gate rolled Doug McNair drove No Soup Tonight to the lead from post two and led the field through opening fractions of :28.1 and :58.3.

Jody Jamieson and Brynley Seelster began a first-up move as the field passed the grandstand for the first time and pressured No Soup Tonight for the next quarter mile. Unfortunately for Jamieson and his filly, odds-on favorite Starlight Dancer followed second-up from fourth, and Johnathan Drury angled out three-wide around the far turn to take the lead and power home in a final panel of 29.1 for a one length score in 1:56.4.

It was the first stakes win for the daughter of Artspeak, who visited the winner's circle once prior on June 23 at Woodbine Mohawk Park. The Melissa Lamoreaux trainee is owned by 1187422 Ontario Inc, and paid \$3.80 for the win.

Tre Ta Ta (Control The Moment) found racing room down the stretch to grab a hard charging second with trainer Beau Brown in the race bike. Brown co-owns the filly with Jennifer Brown of Ostrander, OH, who earned \$25,550 in the biggest score of her young career.

Brynley Seelster was rewarded with a third-place cheque for her effort going first up for over a quarter mile, the same position she finished in the Battle of the Belles at Grand River on Aug. 1. Cambridge, ON resident Jack Darling trains and owns the Big Jim filly.

In the second \$102,200 Gold division **Savethelastdance** stayed undefeated in her young career, winning her third consecutive start, but first at the top level of the OSS.

After moving to the lead through the first turn she went offstride, but James MacDonald was able to get her back on gait and still hold the lead.

The Nick Gallucci trainee held off separate challenges – first from Lyons Bettorday and then a late charging Beca Mitchell in the stretch – to prove the best all the way home in a time of 1:55. She paid \$2.90 for the win.

"Going into the race the only concern with her was going to a new place," said Gallucci. "I think that has to do with why she made a break in the first turn. She doesn't seem to react well to changes, so the biggest concern was not the track size, but just being at a new track."

The filly will return to the familiar confines of Woodbine Mohawk Park for the remainder of the season, where Gallucci believes she can continue her strong form to start her campaign.

"She is used to that track, and so she should stay flat there," said Gallucci. "She has a lot of big dances left, so we will do the best we can. She is definitely progressing and has speed but we are just trying to rate it a little bit."

The late charging Beca Mitchell, piloted by Jody Jamieson, earned her best OSS result of the season for trainer Jason McGinnis in her second-place effort. The Sportswriter filly is owned by Dontworryaboutit Stable (Guelph, ON) and Never 2 Late Stable (Greenlawn, NY).

Trevor Henry navigated second favorite Big Big Plans through a ground saving pocket trip but was able to rally down the stretch and finished third. It was her first loss since her parimutuel debut on June 23, after the All Bets Off daughter swept the Battle of the Belles and won a pair of Gold legs earlier this season.

Robert McIntosh trains and co-owns the filly with Mardon Stables (Loretto, ON) and Dave Boyle (Bowmanville, ON).

In the first division, **Patsville** (Hunstville—Major Master Piece) had her own way going gate to wire in handy fashion.

Patsville (Tyler Buter) took control of the race after Two Proud (Pat Lachance) made a break in turn one after trying to leave. With Wine N Dine Me (Jason Bartlett) and Kele Kele (Matt Kakaley) following intently, Patsville cut quarters of :28.3 and :57.4 before anyone made a forward attempt.

Motoring up the backside, Kele Kele pulled from third and made her way to second on the outside as they were moving past three-quarters. But that challenge fell through when she made a break in the last turn. That left only Wine Me Dinner Me to catch the leader and she couldn't, as Patsville closed out the mile on top by a length in 1:53.3.

Patsville (\$9.10) boosted her earnings to \$130,229 this year on the strength of her third victory for owners William C. De Long and William P. De Long. John Butenschoen trains Patsville, who was bred by Ross Bonafield.

Later in the second split, **Gotthegreenlight** (American Ideal—Bet On Luck) held off a late rush to claim her fifth win in her last six starts.

Gotthegreenlight (Jason Bartlett) out-left Lee Loo (Tyler Buter), grabbed the lead and then hit the brakes to control the pace. Bartlett took the group to the quarter in :28.4 and the half in :58.1 and even then, no right lines were pulled. As they moved onto the second circuit, Gotthegreenlight had a two length lead and finally A Girl That Twirls (Jim Morrill Jr.) tipped out from third and started to advance, forcing a :28 flat third panel.

A Girl That Twirls continued to pace on and looped Lee Loo before the turn and then dropped back in second, right on Gotthegreenlight's back. As they were heading into the home stretch, A Girl That Twirls came back out and paced up alongside Gotthegreenlight, who appeared to be tiring. And although she was just about even with her, Gotthegreenlight had enough left to turn back A Girl That Twirls at the wire to win by one-quarter length in 1:53.2.

Gotthegreenlight (\$2.20) has now amassed \$208,131 this year for owners Patricia Stable and Kovach Stable. Nifty Norman trains the filly that was bred by Stephen P. Day.

Bartlett ended the night with two wins on the card.


