Hambletonian and Pace champs renew battles in Sun Stakes Saturday

Captain Corey and Lawless Shadow lead a stellar stakes cast at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono.

Hambletonian hero Captain Corey and Meadowlands Pace victor Lawless Shadow are amongst an ultra-talented cast that will be on display throughout Sun Stakes Saturday at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono on Aug. 21. In addition to the co-\$300,000 Earl Beal and Max Hempt races that those two horses will respectively headline, the card also features the Delmonica Hanover and James Lynch, both of which go for \$250,000.

Those four races, plus a couple of other invitationals on the card for older pacers and trotters could directly influence the ever-changing state of those divisional races.

Starting with the Earl Beal, Captain Corey makes his first start since his Hambletonian success two weeks ago and has solidified himself as the sport's top 3-year-old colt or gelding trotter. In fact, his Hambletonian win has vaulted him all the way up to the #2 spot in this week's Hambletonian Society/Breeders Crown poll, ranking only behind a near unanimous Manchego. Captain Corey knows this track as well as any, and his form since the Dancer in July has been exquisite. He continues to bolster his own credentials while growing the legend of his sire Googoo



Gaagaa, who coincidentally won this very race here in 2012.

The last time Captain Corey was seen at Pocono was on May 31 when he won a PA sire stake division by over 10 lengths. Svanstedt has continuously driven this one with a take-no-prisoners approach and it seems all but inevitable he'll be the one controlling the race from the top once again. He shouldn't have

much trouble making the lead from post 2 and could intimidate a few others with speed from the outside; seems too good to lose right now especially considering a favorable environment and will look to further his grip on the division.

The main challenger for Captain Corey in the Beal could come from the horse starting immediately to his outside, stablemate Delayed Hanover. It's back to Dexter Dunn for Delayed Hanover, and that was an impressive Hambletonian elimination win the last time these two were paired together. Of course, Yannick Gingras gave Delayed Hanover an ideal two-hole trip in the Hambletonian and Delayed Hanover simply couldn't gain on Captain Corey from that spot when it counted and had to settle for a close enough fourth. A similar fate was encountered by the third Svanstedt trainee in this race Johan Palema in his Hambletonian elimination. He too sat a pocket trip behind Captain Corey only to weaken once into the stretch. The race before Johan Palema beat a few impressive foes in 1:50.4 and I hate to put too much stock into one race, but that last one was tough to figure. Sears put a perfect trip on Sonofamistery in the Hambletonian but couldn't advance off second-over cover. In Range has been a hard luck horse this year. Spy Booth angled to the inside in the late stages of the Hambletonian and was making some inroads; \$273,082 career earner is still a maiden.

On the fillies' side of the 3-year-old pacers, Hot Mess Express enters the James Lynch unbeaten on the year with a 7-for-7 record, though is listed as the third choice in the program coming out of the daunting outside post 9. I thought it was a cinch she'd be favored despite what I thought was an inaccurate 4-1 morning line, but peers on social media seemed to strongly think otherwise. She's already beaten her main rivals in here between the Nadia Lobell and Mistletoe Shalee, but to the earlier point, the outside post won't make it easy. Currently, she sits a couple notches ahead of the Pelling-trained Test Of Faith in the Hambletonian/Breeders Crown and while there's a long way to go in the season, another major win in this circumstance would make a lasting impression.

Elsewhere in the Lynch, Fire Start Hanover raced at Pocono last week and lost at odds of 1-9 for the second straight week. And I hate to be negative, especially on recurring topics, but the effort she received last out was disgraceful. Sent off as the heaviest of favorites in a field of six, Dunn elected to take her off the gate and get away sixth and last. With predictable dull cover with longshots in front of her, she was still last approaching the three quarters and even the announcer was incredulous, speaking how she was ten lengths away with the entire field still to pass. It's all just silly at this point. Even if she wanted an easy race following the prior week's 1-9 defeat in the Shady Daisy, it's not like she would have faced any real opposition in going to the front or controlling the pace in that Pocono race last week. At any rate, she remains sharp and should attract attention off that 5-1 morning line. Grace Hill went a big mile two back at the Meadowlands and then won in another sub-1:50 time last weekend here; hasn't been able to figure out Hot Mess Express yet this year but if there was ever a time to do so it would be now. Blue Diamond Eyes goes for four in a row and has never been better.

Max Hempt

Almost all the big guns are racing in the Max Hempt ,except for the top-ranked sophomore pacing colt or gelding, Charlie May. Though Charlie May leads the way in the division following backside bull rush in the Milstein at Northfield last weekend, several of the horses in the Hempt can further elevate their divisional status with a win.

For starters, Lawless Shadow returns Stateside after his elevated win in the Meadowlands Pace. After getting nailed two back at Georgian Downs where both he and Bulldog Hanover were upset by Desperate Man, he ended up parked in his most recent at Woodbine. He gets Mark MacDonald back and a Hempt win would be a solid addition to his resume. Nothing against Perfect Sting, but I usually let him beat me if he can considering the short prices he typically offers. Perhaps not as dominant as he was at 2, he's still a force week in and week out against these and it's still possible for him to repeat as divisional champion if he can get hot. Hellabalou picked up Tetrick for the Adios final and that was an emotional win for the connections; has proven himself guite a bit since that 81-1 Pace elimination win. That was some first-over mile from Rockyroad Hanover in the Cane Pace to wear down Perfect Sting. He had late pace two back in the Adios as well and is another possibility despite an outside post. Southwind Gendry was better late in his most recent when adding Lasix for the first time. American Courage picked up a confidence building win at Yonkers last out; maybe he's just more suited towards a smaller track.

Delmonica Hanover

In the Delmonica Hanover for 3-year-old filly trotters is an opportunity for someone to step up to potentially go on and eventually challenge Hambletonian Oaks winner Bella Bellini. You Ato Dream had the misfortune of drawing an impossible spot in the Oaks and likely still remains sharp. She was resolute a few back in holding off Lady Chaos and others and will be greatly aided in here by starting from the rail. Mazzarati has been slow to get things on track this year but that try last out in the Continental victory was her best try yet when losing to only the pocket sitter in a two-horse breakaway; picks up Tetrick. She was beaten last out in that race by May Karp who was impressive in gliding by from the pocket. Flawless Country seems bound to be involved and rates as the program favorite as part of the entry but is still yet to finish better than third in seven starts this year. Darlene Hanover hasn't been overly impressive in her last few but she's talented enough to win in a spot like this.



Hambletonian champ Captain Corey ready to return in Beal

In its previous nine editions, the Earl Beal Jr. Memorial for 3-year-old trotters was a precursor to the Hambletonian.

This year, thanks to a later date on the Grand Circuit schedule, the race features the Hambletonian champ.

Captain Corey, who won the \$1 million Hambletonian Stakes on Aug. 7, headlines a nine-horse field in Saturday's \$300,000 Beal Memorial at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono. The colt, trained and driven by Ake Svanstedt, is the 2-1 morning-line favorite as a coupled entry with stablemate Delayed Hanover.

The Beal Memorial is part of Pocono's stakes-filled Sun Stakes Saturday card, which also includes the \$250,000 Delmonica Hanover for 3-year-old female trotters, \$300,000 Max C. Hempt Memorial for 3-year-old pacers, and \$250,000 James M. Lynch Memorial for 3-year-old female pacers. Racing begins at 12:30 p.m. (EDT).

Captain Corey is undefeated in three previous appearances at Pocono, including a stakes-record 1:53.3 triumph in last season's Pennsylvania Sire Stakes championship for 2-year-old male trotters.

For his career, Captain Corey has won eight of 12 starts and \$915,333 for owners S R F Stable, Knutsson Trotting Inc., Midnight Sun Partners Inc., and Ake Svanstedt Inc.

In the Hambletonian, Captain Corey was pressed to a :26 opening quarter, the fastest first quarter in the final's history, and remained under pressure until coming out of the last turn. From there, he pulled away from the field, and won by 1-1/2 lengths in 1:51.

"A lot of people were talking that if they gave Captain Corey some pressure, he would stop," Svanstedt said. "But he is tougher than people understand. Now they know he is a tough horse. He's very nice and friendly, but he's a tough horse."

Captain Corey raced without shoes in the Hambletonian and will go barefoot again in the Beal.

"He was very light and smooth gaited," Svanstedt said. "The time (in the Hambletonian) was (1):51, but I think he can go faster. Normally, they get faster. But that was a different race because they went so fast the first half."

Captain Corey's sire, Googoo Gaagaa, won the 2012 Beal Memorial in a then-world-record 1:50.4.

In addition to Captain Corey, Saturday's Beal includes Hambletonian finalists Spy Booth, who finished second, Delayed Hanover, Take All Comers, Sonofamistery, and Locatelli.

Delayed Hanover, owned by Mellby Gard and Ake Svanstedt Inc., finished fourth in the Hambletonian. Svanstedt also trains Beal contender Johan Palema, who is 3-1 on the morning line. Johan Palema, owned

by Bender Sweden Inc., won the Yonkers Trot in July but missed the Hambletonian after finishing seventh in his elimination.

Johan Palema, who will be driven by Yannick Gingras, has four wins and a second in six starts this year while Delayed Hanover, who will be driven by Dexter Dunn, has three wins and a second in six races. They will join Captain Corey in going barefoot in the Beal.

"Johan Palema raced so good earlier this year, every race was good for him," Svanstedt said. "And then the important race, the Hambletonian elimination, he was bad. He got tired. Maybe he just had a bad day. We couldn't find anything specific wrong. After that, he trained good, and everything seems normal. I hope he can do a good race."

Svanstedt won the 2019 Beal Memorial with Marseille, who upset favorite Greenshoe at odds of 57-1.

Two races prior to the Beal, Svanstedt will send out Flawless Country and Wet My Whistle in the \$250,000 Delmonica Hanover. Svanstedt shares ownership of both fillies, who will race as a coupled entry in the wagering. The entry is the 5-2 morning-line favorite.

Flawless Country finished no worse than second in nine races last year, winning five, including the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes final for 2-year-old filly trotters at Pocono. This year, she is winless in seven starts.

"Maybe we are a little spoiled because she was so good last year," Svanstedt said. "She's raced okay, but maybe the competition is tougher this year. They must move forward from (age) 2 to 3. Maybe she has not moved forward as much as the other horses."

Svanstedt will drive Flawless Country while Gingras will drive Wet My Whistle, who has won four of 19 career starts.

"She has talent, she always trains good, but she must be in a good mood to race good," Svanstedt said about Wet My Whistle. "She has a temper. We can't find out why she is like that. I hope she is in a better mood so that she can race better. She has a bad post (nine). We'll see what she can do."

Snyder family's Aetos Kronos a one horse show at Solvalla

Jerry Riordan's 5-year-old **Aetos Kronos** (Bold Eagle) — owned in part by Jeffrey Snyder and family of New York — has belonged in the top of the Swedish-bred 2016 crop since he was 3 and in \$345,000 Jubileumspokalen at Solvalla on Wednesday (Aug. 18) night, the Bold Eagle son beat some of the best 5-year-olds in Europe.

We didn't see participation from France in Jubileumspokalen, but besides that, many of the most merited 5-year-olds in Europe gathered behind the gate over 1.3 miles at Solvalla.

Surprisingly, five of the 10 participants in the race made breaks in some part of the race, two of them at an early stage as both Axl Rose and Admiral As disappeared before the first turn.

Hail Mary couldn't get his gait together at any stage of the race and Robert Bergh's trotter had to face position first over after a short break during the first quarter.

Magnus A Djuse is one of the most talented young drivers that has climbed the ladder of success the past two, three years and Riordan is not unfamiliar with entrusting new, upcoming drivers for his horses. Djuse knows Aetos Kronos well. The duo participated in Elitloppet in May and when Jubileumspokalen went off, Djuse sent Aetos Kronos to the lead and despite a very quick opening the first 500 meters (and first 5/8, with a mile rate of 1:53.2), Aetos Kronos pulverized his opponents during the last kilometer.

Jerry Riordan's trotter just flew away from the chasers in the last turn and over the stretch of Solvalla, the stage was all Aetos Kronos'. The horse came home in an equaling world record performance (same as Readly Express in the same race 2017) over 1.3 miles as he noted a mile rate of impressive 1:52.2.

Aetos Kronos, partly owned by American Jeff Snyder, who was visiting Solvalla, has collected several group 1-wins in his career and by purse, the victory at Solvalla on Wednesday night was his biggest so far.

Elitloppet winner Don Fanucci Zet finished strongly as runner up after a trip far back in the field while Click Bait held well after a pocket trip.

Emotional victory in European Championship for Mares

The \$230,000 European Championship for Mares was on the Wednesday's (Aug. 18) race card at Solvalla and the outcome of the race was like written in the stars.

Norwegian trainer Trond Andersen, who recently died at an age of 58, had 7-year-old **Miracle Tile** (Cantab Hall) in his barn and when driver Erik Adielsson served the mare a perfect pocket trip, she answered by disarming leader and first choice Mellby Free over the stretch.

Adielsson was emotional in the winner's circle after the race and the entire Norwegian harness racing business must have cried tears of joy when Miracle Tile claimed the prestigious title. Andersen's companion for many years, Kristian Malmin, is now the trainer of the mare.

Miracle Tile came home in a mile rate of 1:53.3 over 1.3 miles.

Dorgos de Guez best at Enghien

The \$152,000 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere at Paris track Enghien became a quite messy story over 1.7 miles and as many times before in France, Jean-Michel Bazire claimed the title, this time


paired with his chestnut **Dorgos de Guez** (Romcok de Guez), who found enough space to sprint to victory with less than 150 meters to go.

Dorgos de Guez was placed fourth on the inside and had many lengths to collect to the front horses at mid-stretch, but Bazire was very calm in the bike and trusted his horse as the duo got closer to the leaders just 50 meters ahead of the wire.

Feerie Wood was second and Davidson du Pont third.

Fashionably late

The 2021 Hambletonian went off at 6:13 p.m., the latest it's ever been since moving to The Meadowlands in 1981.

The trend towards a later post time has been going on for the last decade, shifting from 3:47 p.m. to 5:17 p.m. in just four years starting in 2011. That 5:15 p.m. window, give or take a few minutes either way, had been the pattern for eight years, save for the pandemic year in 2020, when nothing was normal.

"I would say Jeff [Gural] in the past two or three years wanted [the Hambletonian] to be the last or second to last race because he felt big events should be the closing race or have a getaway race after that," said Moira Fanning, director of publicity/chief operating officer of the Hambletonian Society.

The Hambletonian is certainly not the first major race to lean a little later. In the past 20 years, the Kentucky Derby post time has rolled from approximately 5:30 p.m. in 2000 to 6:59 p.m. this year, also its latest in history.

"At The Meadowlands, everything is about timing to us as far as the positioning of our races, not just on a big card like the Meadowlands Pace or Hambletonian Day, but our overnight races as well," said Meadowlands' chief operating officer and general manager Jason Settlemoir. "We try to position ourselves so we're maximizing the number of eyeballs on the TV sets throughout simulcasting, throughout the world."

Many things go into choosing a race's proper start time. Handle and attendance being two of the major concerns, but with the



Hambletonian, the Society bylaws must also be considered since they state that the race must take place during the daytime.

In 1979, the pitch presented by the New Jersey Sports & Exposition Authority to bring the Hambletonian to The Meadowlands from DuQuoin, IL, involved keeping it an afternoon delight.

"DuQuoin perfected the county fair big-event venue for [the Hambletonian]," said Fanning. "It was very important to the Society, the people in the sport, to preserve that and not just have it be another nighttime big race. There's nothing wrong with those nighttime big races, but this set the Hambletonian apart. So, they promised to keep it in the day. They promised to recreate the country fair atmosphere. It has certainly changed formats, it has changed times, but it has been preserved as the big daytime event like the [Little Brown] Jug."

The Hambletonian has been broadcast live or on tape delay all 41 years it has been at The Meadowlands and many believe that the movement of the race is predicated on finding available air time, which apparently is inaccurate.

"This is not 1986 when the network said, 'You're on between 4 and 5,' then you're on between 4 and 5," said Fanning. "The network now says, 'When do you want to be on? I'm sure we have a slot."

Since the Hambletonian is not currently broadcast on one of the big three networks – ABC, CBS, or NBC – it does not need to compete with the PGA Tour or other sporting events and therefore has flexibility.

This year it had an hour on CBS Sports Network and 20 minutes on Fox Sports 2 (FS2) during its live coverage of Whitney Day from Saratoga Racecourse.

"To be on two different networks is something that I was very happy and proud about," said John Campbell, president and chief executive officer of the Hambletonian Society. "I didn't have any preference whether it was the last race or not, I just knew that 6:12 fit really well in between those Saratoga stakes."

The Hambletonian and Oaks, for the first time, were part of the New York Racing Association's Cross Country Pick-5, which also included two races from Saratoga and one from Monmouth Park.

"It was perfectly placed, and we certainly appreciate our friends there working with us at FS2, the NYRA guys, Tony Allevato, Eric Donovan and David O'Rourke for their support and giving this a try this year," said Settlemoir. "After speaking with Tony after the Hambletonian card, I think that we were all excited about where we were and where we could go with this in the future."

By making the Hambletonian race 15 on the 16-race card that got underway at noon, it made for a long day in North America and a long evening for the avid fans in Europe.

Both Sweden's ATG and France's PMU took wagering on more Hambletonian Day races this year as opposed to 2020. The ATG took 15 races, three more than last year, while the PMU added one more race, upping their total to six.

Betting in North America was up 13 per cent over 2020 with \$6,487,839 wagered on the day, making it the best Meadowlands' handle so far in 2021, with the top two races bet being the Hambletonian Oaks (\$486,594) and Hambletonian (\$866,013). Preliminary numbers in Europe also appear to be heading in a positive direction.

"I think it shows you the impact that The Meadowlands' Hambletonian Day card has, not just here in North America, but throughout the world where people are actually staying up later to watch and wager on these races," said Settlemoir. "I think you can see that pushing the Hambletonian back to the 15th race out of 16 on the card certainly had a major impact."

Once all the final numbers are in, Campbell and his staff will sit down with Gural, Settlemoir and their staff to discuss what to do for 2022.

"The handle on the Hambletonian and the Oaks was very strong, so I'm very happy with the experiment and how we did it this year," said Campbell. "I believe we have to be very fluid in our decision making, but at the same time, I'm very happy with the way the day went. I'm very happy with the betting and I'm happy that we tried moving the race back and I expect it'll be somewhere in the same vicinity of time next year in that 6:10 to 6:15 window. That's just my thought process now. I take a great deal of pride in Hambletonian Day. I don't think there's anything like it in harness racing."





Iron-tough millionaire Nirvana Seelster retired

After seven years of waging weekly battles with the very best pacers in Ontario, the iron tough Nirvana Seelster has ceded the field of play.

"He's out with a pony on the farm. He'll always have a home," said trainer Bill Budd. "They'll put a saddle on him once and a while and ride him. He likes that, too."

Nirvana Seelster made his last appearance in an overnight on Sept. 12, 2020, and after a winter of rest and relaxation Budd tested the gelding in two qualifiers this spring before calling owner Bruce Davy and telling him the old warhorse had fought his last battle. Week in and week out for the better part of seven years, the son of Camluck and No Strikes Against competed in the top classes at Woodbine and Mohawk Park, taking on the who's who of Ontario racing.

"He raced against some great horses, had some great duels coming down the stretch. He far exceeded any expectations I had, was just fantastic," said Davy. "He wasn't what you call a super horse, he was just real good. He never stood out, never won by a great margin, but he was always there."

From 2014 to 2020, Nirvana Seelster made 241 starts. He won 46 times, was second on 47 occasions and third 40 times. He banked \$1.2 million for Davy, who picked him up for \$6,500 when previous owners Dave Menary, Kenneth Ewen, Denis Breton and Brad Gray listed him for sale in January of his 3-year-old year. The original partners had purchased Nirvana Seelster for \$77,000 from the 2012 Forest City Yearling Sale, but the pacer had failed to advance far enough in his training to qualify as a 2-year-old.

Budd sent him behind the gate for his first lifetime start on the last day of March, 2014 and Nirvana Seelster made his first appearance in the Woodbine Racetrack winner's circle two weeks later. The gelding would make five appearances in the Ontario Sires Stakes Grassroots program that summer, winning twice, both with heroic late sprints.

Between the Grassroots Championship, where Nirvana Seelster finished third, and the Ontario Boys Series in February, the gelding had learned how to leave and he went gate-to-wire in both legs and the final of the Ontario Boys.

"He just progressively kept getting better," said Davy. "He was a finisher and then of course he got that he could leave, and he was just one great horse to be around."

By the end of his 4-year-old season Nirvana Seelster had joined the preferred ranks and he spent most of the next five years racing in that class, taking on future millionaires like Evenin Of Pleasure, Fool Me Once, McWicked, Nickle Bag, Sintra and State Treasurer. He never won another open stake event, coming close twice in the Mohawk Gold Cup (2017 and 2019), but he did deal Lazarus N a memorable defeat in September 2018.

"He got a standing ovation for that," said Budd. "I said we can't go much higher here you know; to beat a horse like that."

After qualifying to start his career, Nirvana Seelster did not set foot in another qualifier until May of his eight-year-old season and he did not qualify again until this spring. The pacer clocked his 1:48 personal best in a Sept. 23, 2017 preferred, keeping a

neck in front of Easy Lover Hanover and Sintra off a front-end effort for driver Trevor Henry.

Over his seven-year career Nirvana Seelster was driven by many of Woodbine Mohawk Park's top reinsman, but the regulars were Henry, Phil Hudon and Rick Zeron, and Budd and Davy are grateful to each of the horsemen who contributed to the pacer's success and longevity.

Along the way there were suitors for the preferred class regular, but Davy got involved with racing because of his affection for horses and he was never tempted to part with Nirvana Seelster.

"He had a couple offers on him and Bruce didn't want to sell him," said Budd. "He was offered big money for him, but he just said, 'No, I think I'll hang on to him."

With Nirvana Seelster's retirement, Davy has just one horse in training. Three-year-old pacing filly Postscript put together a record of one win, one second and three thirds in 12 starts for earnings of \$67,203 after the Brockville, ON resident purchased her last July, but she has yet to cash a check in four sophomore starts. The long-time owner said the Sportswriter daughter could be his last racehorse, especially if current public health restrictions continue into 2022.

"We're winding right down. With COVID a lot of the fun has gone out of it. I've owned her for over a year and never seen her," said the 83-year-old owner, who recently moved Postscript to Budd's barn. "I live four hours away from the Mohawk track and you can't go there and go in the barns or anything, so it's not the same."

Budd said plans are afoot for a commemorative race at Woodbine Mohawk Park to mark the gelding's retirement and Davy will definitely make the trip west for that event; one last celebration of the best horse he has ever owned.

With the recent announcement of \$1.16 million winner Easy Lover Hanover's retirement by trainer Ben Wallace and owner Brad Grant, there is a changing of the guard taking place in Woodbine Mohawk Park's top classes. New faces like Warrawee Vital, Century Farroh and Matticulous GB have begun to battle in

what Davy calls the 'Saturday Night Special,' but the youngsters have a long way to go before they can be referenced in the same company as the recently retired warriors.

"He's just been a great horse," said Budd. "He'd do anything for you. He was always there. Old Nirvana, he's the best."

New policy on racing horses barefoot at The Meadowlands

By now, it's common knowledge that trainer/driver Ake Svanstedt pulled all four shoes on Hambletonian winner Captain Corey just before the race and commented afterward that he felt that racing the horse barefooted played a significant role in the win.

What did not happen as successfully was the passing of that information along to our wagering customers in time for them to include it in their handicapping (as explained by Bob Pandolfo in an **Aug. 11 guest column for HRU**)

The knowledge that a horse will be racing barefoot would be information just as important to a horseplayer as a shoeing change, bridle change or hopple lengthening.

As a result, when live racing returns on Friday, Sept. 3, The Meadowlands will require trainers to report their intent to remove a horse's shoes to the judges or paddock judge no later than 90 minutes before post time for the first race for each racing card.

This will allow time for the change to be reported to the public by the TV talent in advance of any horizontal wagers and be discussed by them as they provide their analysis.

The horse must race as reported, with the possible exception of a significant change in track condition due to weather. In that case the trainer must report to the paddock judge that the shoes will remain on the horse.

It shall be the responsibility of the trainer to report any such changes. The failure to do so or to race the horse as reported without the permission of the judges may result in penalty.



Millar Farms sweeps 2-year-old pacing filly Gold Leg

Driver James MacDonald, trainer Nick Gallucci and owner/breeder Millar Farms of Stouffville, ON swept the third leg of the 2-year-old pacing filly Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Gold Series at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Tuesday (Aug. 17) as **Silver Label** and **Prohibition Legal** turned in impressive performances.

Silver Label was first out of the gate for the Millar Farms team, starting from Post 5 in the first \$103,000 Gold division. When many of his peers opted to float away from the gate, MacDonald shifted Silver Label into gear and the filly led the field of 10 to a :27.1 opening quarter. The fan favorites yielded briefly to Watch Her Dance, but MacDonald had Silver Label back in front by the :55.1 half. Around the final turn Silver Label opened up three lengths on her peers and was on cruise control down the stretch, pacing under the wire in a personal best 1:52. Fade Out and Love That Smile closed well for second and third, three and one-quarter lengths behind Silver Label. (replay here: Silver Label)

"It was nice seeing her pace around the turn, the way she opened up on them. I think that was a really big step forward for her, she kind of proved herself as one of the tops in the division now," said Gallucci. "She is really confident right now and she's just really full of herself. We couldn't really ask for much more from her at this point."

Gallucci said the daughter of Bettors Delight and Hidden Gem trained down like a professional all winter, but her full siblings were more successful as older horses so they were hopeful, but not confident that she would fulfill her potential this season.

"She always seemed to do everything so easy; all the steps were so easy for her," said the Stouffville resident. "It seems like one of her best attributes is you can do whatever you want with her. You can leave, you can take her off the gate, she's just really willing.

"She's just got so many gears; hopefully we haven't seen the bottom of her yet."

The win was Silver Label's second in Gold Series action and her fourth in four starts. She was also victorious in the July 6 Grassroots opener at Georgian Downs and in an Aug. 2 overnight at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Four races later Gallucci was overcome with emotion when Prohibition Legal put on a display of raw power, closing from fifth to collar pacesetting favorite Balance and pocket-sitter Flo in a personal best 1:52. Two week ago the filly was at the University of Guelph's Equine Clinic with a bout of abdominal pain and the Millar Farms' team did not know whether she would race again this summer, let alone recover in time to compete in Tuesday's leg.

"Luckily the University was able to do it medically and didn't have to do surgery," said Gallucci, noting that the filly spent five

days in Guelph. "We really dodged a big bullet there, we were all really nervous, hoping that they wouldn't have to do surgery and lose the year.

"This win was just so special. It's one I am not going to forget."

Gallucci kept MacDonald apprised of the filly's health status and was grateful that the driver stuck with the two-time Gold winner. In addition to Prohibition Legal, the Guelph, ON resident had the option to drive Balance, who he guided to a commanding 1:53.2 win in the Whenuwishuponastar Final on Aug. 10. The trainer also appreciated the trip MacDonald crafted for Prohibition Legal. (replay here: Prohibition Legal)

"It's just unbelievable how fast this horse can come off a helmet, and that was the first time we really got to see it in a race. The other races she was first over and on the lead, and I think this is her best racing tactics, off the pace and coming off a helmet," said Gallucci of the daughter of Big Jim and Catch A Wish. "It's pretty surreal to watch her do it, it's amazing. For everything she went through, she made us all really proud and I'm really happy for George (Millar). It's just really amazing."

So long as they remain happy and healthy, in the coming weeks Silver Label and Prohibition Legal's schedules will diverge. Silver Label has the remaining Gold Series events, Sept. 3 and Oct. 2 at Woodbine Mohawk Park, and the Sept. 11 Champlain Stakes. Prohibition Legal has those, along with the Aug. 28 Eternal Camnation and the Shes A Great Lady, with eliminations Sept. 18 and the final Sept. 25, among her options.

"We'll just kind of take it week to week and hope that they're ready to go when the money is on the line. Luckily these fillies have been so far, hopefully it carries forward," said Gallucci. "It would be really nice to win one of the major Grand Circuit races, but I am just as happy winning a Gold. It's really amazing wining these races."

It will return to the Meadowlands for the first time since 2016. This championship event plans to be showcased in the fall on the weekends of Oct. 22 and 23 and Oct. 29 and 30.

Clearly, we could not be where we are today without the consistent support of our state legislators and the relationships that we have forged. With their assistance, we believe that the future will bring even more success and prosperity to the Garden State.
