MAX C. HEMPT MEMORIAL PACE

\$300,000 Hempt Pace: The importance of track geometry was never shown more clearly than in the \$300,000 Max C. Hempt Memorial Pace for 3-year-old males, as **Beach Glass** and driver Yannick Gingras took full advantage of the rail to defeat "hot horse" and favorite Bythemissal in 1:50.

Beach Glass and Bythemissal, who started from post three, had their hooves all the way down on the accelerator early, with Beach Glass able to keep Bythemissal outside en route to a searing :25.2 quarter before the latter tucked second.

Harness Racing Update

The hoof shifted from gas to brake in the second quarter, with Beach Glass able to back the half off to :55.1. Bythemissal (Chris Page) came back for more first-over down the back, with the three-quarters reached in 1:22 (partially attributable to the backstretch tailwind / homestretch headwind).

It wasn't just these two colts slugging it out late: Layton Hanover, at 80-1, menaced in the Pocono Pike, and Fourever Boy was narrowing in quickly. But it was Beach Glass, a colt by trainer Brent MacGrath's beloved Somebeachsomewhere, who earned the half-length decision. "He needed the week off," MacGrath said after the race, "and he trained really well this week." He ended his interview with the understatement of the day: "Post position means a lot."

As they turned for home, driver Mark MacDonald took **The Greatest Ending** to the inside,

and the Somebeachsomewhere colt dug in and outfooted Early Action by a half-length while equaling his mark in 1:50.3. Dr. Ian Moore conditions the winner, who more than doubled his lifetime bankroll to \$178,342 for owner Reginald Petitpas.

The \$100,000 Hempt Consolation II saw the Burke Brigade finish 1-2 after being at opposite ends of the pack at headstretch: the Sweet Lou gelding **JM'S Final Treasure** took over the lead near the second turn, then hung on over a tightly-packed group in 1:52 for driver Yannick Gingras and the ownership of Burke Racing Stable LLC, Weaver Bruscemi LLC, J&T Silva- Purnel & Libby, and Phil Collura. Birthday, last as they turned for home, came flying home to finish only a head back.

DELMONICA HANOVER TROT

\$250,000 Delmonica Hanover: **Joviality** continued his lifelong devastating form in the \$250,000 Delmonica Hanover Trot for sophomore fillies, going up uncovered on Jiggy Jog S then going past her approaching headstretch then drawing off to win by 4½ lengths in 1:51.3, a stakes record and equaling the track record co-held by Check Me Out (2012) and Designed To Be (2014).

Brian Sears, who in post-race comments remarked how easy the Chapter Seven filly is to drive, sat third while Pink Coco Chanel, second to Fashion Schooner in the Hambletonian Oaks, left strongly to take over the racetrack before the :26.3 quarter and extended Jiggy Jog S before letting her go to the top at three-eighths, hitting the half in :55.1. Sears came uncovered with the winner of \$1,616,818 down the backstretch, trotted up to the leader by the 1:23 three-quarters and powered right past her on the turn (coming out of which Jiggy Jog S broke), and finished out strongly on her own ability.

Owned by Courant Inc., Joviality S combined with Temporal Hanover to give trainer Marcus Melander a sweep of the day' top sophomore trots. She extended her extraordinary record to 9-7-1-1 and 21-16-3-1 lifetime, with many late seasoned rich races to come, and then a decision about her future.

Delmonica Hanover Consolation: **Misswalner Fashion** won the Continentalvictory in her last time after closing front last to first in the last stanza; in the \$125,000 Delmonica Hanover Consolation Tim Tetrick sent the Walner filly to the lead in front of the stands and kept her going to the wire for a 1:53.4 success by a length. Misswalner Fashion is trained by Jim Campbell, the star of Hambletonian Day two weeks ago, for owner Jules Siegel; second after racing first-over was another Fashion Farms/Campbell product, Design Fashion.





Sweet Kisses pulls off 10-1 upset in the Lynch

Sweet Kisses continued her winning ways with a second consecutive Grand Circuit stakes upset, capturing Saturday's \$250,000 James M. Lynch Memorial for 3-year-old female pacers by 1-3/4 lengths over Sea Silk in 1:50 at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono. Max Contract finished third.

Sweet Kisses, who won the Adioo Volo on July 30 at odds of 34-1, scored in the Lynch at 10-1 for driver Todd McCarthy and trainer Ron Burke. It was the filly's fourth consecutive victory and fifth in her past six starts, with the setback coming by a head.


McCarthy and Sweet Kisses were fourth as 6-5 favorite Max Contract, who brought a four-race win streak to the Lynch, led the field to the opening quarter in :26.1 and half in :54.2. Sweet Kisses started to make a move on the backstretch and picked up cover from second-place Sea Silk, who came first over on Max Contract as they hit three-quarters in 1:21.4.

Coming off the final turn, Sweet Kisses moved to the center of the track and stormed past her rivals in the stretch to get her sixth win in 11 starts this season.

"I knew that I was going to be following a good one from the half," McCarthy said. "When I turned her loose at the top of the stretch, she had a big heart about it and wanted to go forward. I was very pleased."

McCarthy, who won last year's Lynch with Grace Hill in a stakes-record 1:49, said the track conditions were favorable for horses to come from off the pace.

"If you use them a little bit too much early, they seem to struggle getting home a little bit, not to mention there is a little bit of a headwind in the stretch too," McCarthy said. "It's making for very fair racing."

Saturday marked the first time McCarthy drove Sweet Kisses.

"You're always grateful to pick up drives in these kinds of races, especially one of Ronnie's because you know he's going to have them spot-on," McCarthy said. "I'm super appreciative for that. He told me a little bit about her, and he couldn't have been more correct. She raced super. True to his word, she was terrific."

Sweet Kisses is owned by Burke Racing Stable, J&T Silva-Purnel & Libby, Knox Services, and Phil Collura. She is a daughter of Sweet Lou-Kiss Me and was bred by Concord Stud Farm. For her career, she has won eight of 14 races and earned \$243,077.

She paid \$22.40 to win.

In the \$125,000 Lynch Consolation I, **Balance** was fifth on the final turn before tipping off the pylons and rallying on the far outside of a five-horse battle to the wire to win by a neck over Just Divine in a lifetime-best 1:51.2. Galleria Hanover was fourth-placed-third, swapping places with Sweet Treasure who was dropped for a passing lane violation.

Balance, the 4-1 third choice, was driven by Dexter Dunn for trainer Nancy Takter. She is owned by Diamond Creek Racing and Crossover Racing. The filly, a daughter of Bettor's Delight-West Of L A, was bred by Robert McIntosh Stables, C S X Stables, and Al McIntosh Holdings. Balance has won four of 16 career races and earned \$246,729.

In the \$75,000 Lynch Consolation II, **Free To Be Me** was fifth on the inside at three-quarters but angled wide coming off the final turn and sprinted to a career-best 1:51.4 win by a half-length over Miss Helen Hanover. Eager To Please finished third.

Free To Be Me, sent off as the 4-1 third choice, was driven by Matt Kakaley for trainer Jake Leamon. The filly is owned by Saulsbrook Stables, Michael McKenzie, and Edward Gorc. The daughter of **Always B Miki**-Indulge Me was bred by Stonegate Standardbred Farms. She has won six of 17 career races and earned \$71,720.

Temporal Hanover impressive in \$300,000 Earl Beal Jr. Memorial

Temporal Hanover got the lead prior to the opening quarter and stayed on top from there, winning Saturday's \$300,000 Earl Beal Jr. Memorial for 3-year-old male trotters by one length over Pretender in 1:53. Pour Mea Double finished third and Hambletonian champ Cool Papa Bell was fourth despite making a break at the start.

Temporal Hanover, who was beaten by three-quarters of a length in finishing third in the Hambletonian final on Aug. 6 and by a head in his Hambo elimination a week earlier, took the field through fractions of :26.4, :56.3, and 1:24.4 to capture the Beal as the 4-5 favorite.

"He was used a little hard, but I figured I was going to try to steal as much as I could going to the half," winning driver Brian Sears said. "He kicked home.

"This horse really deserves it. He's been racing great all year. He's won a couple big ones, and he deserves another."



Temporal Hanover, trained by Marcus Melander, won the Dr. Harry M. Zweig Memorial Main Event on July 9 and has posted four wins, three seconds, and a third in eight starts this season. He was a multiple Grand Circuit winner last year.

"It worked out perfectly today," Melander said. "It's a little tough to go to the lead because there are some strong winds out there, so he did a good job.

"He's a good horse, he's an honest horse, and he's been racing good all year. He was first over both the eliminations and final of the Hambletonian, so I thought he was going to have a good shot today."

Temporal Hanover is owned by AMG Stable, Kenneth Kjellgren, Rick Wahlstedt, and Heights Stable. The colt, a son of Walner-Think Twice, was bred by Hanover Shoe Farms. For his career, he has won nine of 20 races and earned \$766,291.

He paid \$3.80 to win.

The Earl Beal Jr. Memorial honors the former president of the Pennsylvania Harness Horsemen's Association who helped bring casino gaming to the state's racetracks.

In the \$200,000 Beal Consolation I, **Molotov Cocktail** settled in fourth as World At War Deo and King Of The North battled head-to-head to the half, circled three-wide on the backstretch, picked up cover from El Toro Loco on the final turn, and marched to victory by three-quarters of a length over B A Superhero in 1:52.4. El Toro Loco was third.

Molotov Cocktail, the 8-5 favorite, was driven by Brian Sears for trainer Linda Toscano. The colt is owned by Richard Gutnick, Tom Pontone, and Gary Cocco. The son of Chapter Seven-Moonlight Cocktail was bred by Gutnick and T L P Stable. He has won seven of 15 lifetime races and earned \$348,952.

In the \$100,000 Beal Consolation II, **Stride The Hill** left quickly from post six to get good early position, was on the pylons in third at three-quarters, and rallied inside through the lane following a misstep by favorite Robertsin to win by three-quarters of a length over Nice Guy Eddie in 1:53.3. Famous Father finished third.

Stride The Hill, sent off at 9-1, was driven by Tim Tetrick for trainer Jim Campbell. The gelding is owned by Fashion Farms. A son of Muscle Hill-Open Access, he was bred by Fair Winds Farm. For his career, Stride The Hill has won four of 20 races and earned \$136,652.



Allywag Hanover, Cuatro De Julio win Pocono invitationals

Allywag Hanover (Todd McCarthy) won the \$100,000 Always B Miki final for open pacers on Saturday at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono.

Allywag Hanover was a repeat winner in the \$100,000 Always B Miki Pace for older stars during Sun Stakes Saturday at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono, with Todd McCarthy in his usual perch behind last year's divisional champion – while Todd's brother Andrew accounted for the \$100,000 Sebastian K S Trot, the companion event, in an impressive 1:51.

Allywag Hanover, a Captaintreacherous gelding owned by Allywag Stable, left from post four and turned loose American Courage, who left just outside him, not that long before a :25.2 opening stanza. The third fast early starter was Ruthless Hanover, from post eight, but after going three-wide the first three-sixteenths, he could not make the lead or the pocket, and was doomed to taking the air through fractions of :54.2 and 1:21.2. After those fractions anybody would melt off, and the last eighth became a stout battle between American Courage and Allywag Hanover, with "Allywag" finding the extra gear to gain into the :27 kicker and turn back his game foe by a length.



Cuatro De Julio (Andrew McCarthy) won the \$100,000 Sebastian K final for open trotters on Saturday at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono in 1:51..

After the race trainer Brett Pelling noted that "this is really his ideal trip – second-in, third-in, chasing after someone. I'd rather have him with someone to pace to than be on the lead." Pelling indicated the horse's near-future itinerary included stops at Dayton, Hoosier, and The Red Mile.

The Trixton 4-year-old stallion **Cuatro De Julio** was just about as impressive a winner as anybody in the Sebastian K S, leaving behind two millionaire mares, Bella Bellini (third) and When Dovescry (break), and other tough opponents by moving at the :27 quarter and getting the lead, posting mid-splits of :55.3 and 1:23.2 before finishing the mile two lengths ahead of two-holer Hillexotic. (If you think you've detected a speed/inside bias on the day, you're correct; only three winners were successful using an overland route for most of the last half.)

Cuatro De Julio' effort gained further status when it is noted that his time was only two-fifths of a second off the divisional world record set here by Uncle Peter in 2013, and a stake mark. Trainer Marie Ortolan Bar, co-owner with D Farm LLC, kept up her streak of being the happiest person in the winners circle after her prized trotter won.

TALES FROM THE CURMUDGEON

Garnet Barnsdale on a lifetime in the game

Handicapper, writer and harness racing super farn.

Garnet Barnsdale has been going to the racetrack since he was four years old. He is now 57. When asked how long he has been wagering on horses, his response is that he has been betting for almost as long as he has been going to the track. He began going to the track during the days of Old Woodbine, soon to become Greenwood.


"Those were the great days, for me anyway he says. My dad, who loved horse racing, especially betting on the horses, would take me along with him most of the times that he went. I've replicated those experiences with my son Nicholas. Back then, we probably went to see the thoroughbreds as often as the harness horses, perhaps even more. I liked both breeds, but even then, my favorites were the trotters and pacers. I suppose the main reason was that I could relate more to the drivers as opposed to the jockeys. In order to ride horses in races you had to be quite small. That is one thing I grew out of quickly when I hit puberty. Drivers, on the other hand, especially back then, came in all shapes and sizes. That was something I could dream of becoming or at least practicing. I could never imagine myself sitting astride a thoroughbred.

"Betting always intrigued me. I handicapped horse races from the first time I could read a program, perhaps even earlier. I loved the challenge of 'picking the winner.' Somewhere in my memory I looked back to the times when I would pick my choices from the way a horse looked in the post parade, or the way the driver sat in the bike or perhaps the way the horse scored down. My dad might give me two bucks to bet on a given horse or would allow me to share one of his bets.

"Those Greenwood days were glorious. Greenwood might have been the best located racetrack ever. It was on Queen Street east in downtown Toronto, easily accessed by public transportation.



The streetcar stopped immediately in front of the track's main entrance. I often look back and think of what horse racing missed out on when the decision was made to sell it. There would be a good possibility that if that track were still there and functioning as a racino that it would be the most successful one in North



America, or perhaps even the world. I understand that economic factors made the selling of the land essential to the preservation of the then Ontario Jockey Club (now Woodbine Entertainment) a must do, but a guy can dream, can't he?"


Barnsdale was involved with racing throughout his youth through to the present era. But horse racing was not exclusive in his likes. He liked just about all sports and developed a deep interest in most of them. Along with his interest in most sports, he also became involved in the wagering opportunities.

His interest in horse racing, specifically of the harness variety led to an avocation associated with handicapping, writing and general fandom for about 40 years. In his final year at Humber College, Garnet interned at the now defunct *Standardbred Magazine* which was owned and operated by Barb Lennox (daughter of Keith Waples), who died earlier this year.

Q: Most people who do not know you — and perhaps some that do — might be surprised to find that your handicapping, writing and general interest in the sport is secondary to your day job. You really have another means of making a living — what might be considered in the "real" world as a 9 to 5 job.

"That is so. Although, I'm not certain that if the opportunity for full time employment in racing had presented itself sometime in my formative years, that I would have not jumped at the chance to go where my heart probably would have dictated. I actually started out with the intent of possibly becoming a full-time journalist. I graduated from Humber College here in Toronto with honors in journalism. From there I worked at waste management where I spent 22 years. I then went to work at The Region of Peel, where I've been for the last eight years. As supervisor of waste collection, I am responsible to ensure that curbside waste gets collected from 350,000 homes every week in three municipalities that border Toronto to the west: The cities of Mississauga and Brampton and the Town of Caledon. It is an always interesting job, and, garbage is recession proof.

"The genesis of my current involvement in the harness racing journalism started with miniature horses, believe it or not. We owned some at the time, and I had a chance to drive one in a miniature horse race at Hanover Raceway, a B track here in Ontario. I contacted Peter Gross who publishes the racehorse newspaper, *Down The Stretch*, devoted to thoroughbreds, standardbreds and quarter horses in Ontario, to see if he might be interested in running a story about my driving experience. I suppose that's where my horse writing career began. From there, I started doing Mohawk Park picks for a now defunct website and I guess I was noticed by *DRF Harness* editor Derick



Those Greenwood days were glorious. Greenwood might have been the best located racetrack ever. It was on Queen Street east in downtown Toronto, easily accessed by public transportation. The streetcar stopped immediately in front of the track's main entrance. I often look back and think of what horse racing missed out on when the decision was made to sell it. There would be a good possibility that if that track were still there and functioning as a racino that it would be the most successful one in North America, or perhaps even the world. I understand that economic factors made the selling of the land essential to the preservation of the then Ontario Jockey Club (now Woodbine Entertainment) a must do, but a guy can dream, can't he?

came at the 2020 O'Briens when I won the Media Excellence Award for a piece I wrote on my dear friend and Hall of Famer Bill Galvin. To me, that validated that all the hard work that I did the previous 10 years was worth it."

at all of the B tracks that I handicap. I try to memorize these horses as much as possible because all \$7K claimers are not equal. Understanding each one's ability and racing tendencies gives me an edge."


Q: Are you acquainted with all the horses that you do the handicapping on? If so, how do you follow all of them?

"I am and I do. I feel that I'd be somehow cheating if I didn't, because I need to have as much information as possible to do my job and I like to think that, at least sometimes, I provide my readers with useful information they don't have themselves. In general, as a fan and as a lover of the sport, I feel that in terms of whether simulcasting is good or bad for the sport I would tend to go with the good. However, there is a down side. It keeps people from attending the races and having a better knowledge of the horses and those involved with them. Of all the ails of the sport, I think that lagging track attendance is something that if it isn't already there, will contribute to the lessening interest in harness racing. However, for what I do in terms of handicapping it is a necessity. I'm at home watching races from all over for many hours of the day. Without simulcasting that would be pretty much impossible. It's a big aid for me. Take \$7,000 claimers for example. They make up the bulk of races

Q: Let's go back in time. You started going to Greenwood Raceway and then continued by going to Woodbine, Mohawk and Garden City. What is it that you remember about these places.

"The one thing that applies to all of them is the people factor and the atmosphere created by those people. There is something good and more exciting with people around while you are watching the horses race. This doesn't only apply to horse racing, it applies to all sports. At Greenwood, we had the extra bonus of having the open paddock in the middle of the grandstand where the fans could see the horses and drivers and even interact with them. I've never seen this at any other track and I cannot understand why not.

"I'm afraid that with the exception of major racing days or nights such as the North American Cup, the Hambletonian, the Little Brown Jug and perhaps the upcoming Grand Circuit stakes seasons, highlighted by the Breeders Crowns that we've lost that. I cannot think of anything we can do to replace it. Of course, the addition of sports betting can and possibly will



negatively impact us. But there is a way to turn that negative into a positive. We are a sport. Why in the world are we not considered an integral part of sports wagering? To me that is a given. All we need to do is convince the powers that be to include us. I know that in Ontario, WEG CEO Jim Lawson has been working hard trying to get horse racing on all of the sports gambling sites platforms that started up here in April of this year. That would create some great exposure for the sport up here, and you would hope, produce an increase in handle."

Q: Do you have any favorites among the numerous horses and horsemen that you've seen?

"With horses, my all-time favorite would be San Pail. There were very few of his races that I didn't see. He was close to the perfect horse in my estimation. You'd see him often and more often than not you'd then see him in the winner's circle. He had most of the ingredients. He was a hometown hero who came from rather humble beginnings By racing for several years he built up a significant fan base.

"But, it was more than that. My (now deceased) sister was a huge fan of San Pail and in her last days, she was invited to go see him at Rod Hughes' farm. That was actually the last day she got out of hospice prior to passing away two weeks later and she referred to it as the "best day ever." For that I am forever grateful to the Hughes family and the great champion San Pail.

"With horsemen, most people who know me know that I idolize Ron Waples. He did everything and did it all well. In addition, he is a great person who was and still is readily accessible to just about everybody. Of all the thousands of races he has won, one stood out to me. I remember it as though it was yesterday. It was the final of a stakes which he won with Dream Maker in the then astonishing time of 1.56. Ronnie is a real credit to the sport. Prior to Waples, my favorite was another Ron, Ronnie Feagan who dominated the OJC when I was in my early teens. His early passing was a real loss for the sport."

Q: You have an interest in just about all the high profile sports. Which is your favorite?

"I almost always cheer for the home team. I love the Raptors, the Blue Jays and the Leafs. But my all-time favorite plays football less than a hundred miles from home. I'm a huge Buffalo Bills fan and season-ticket holder. Not being able to go to their games during COVID was a real kick in the butt for me. I love football almost as much as harness racing."

Q: What is it you dislike most about racing today?

"I hate the post time drag, but I think we are past the point of no return with it. I'll give you an extreme example of the (appropriately named) drag. I was watching coverage of a major

stakes race recently and I swear there was OMTP on the screen for 20 minutes before any horses even came out on the track. What is the point of that and how do I explain it to a newbie? Unfortunately, it has been proven that when a track removes the drag it loses handle. But I still dislike it. Maybe the answer is a concerted effort by all racetracks over a reasonable period of time — perhaps enough time to acclimate the customers to believe that a specific time is when the race will go off. But that would involve cooperation, something that most racetracks haven't shown any inclination for."

Q: Your son Nicholas appears to be following a road similar to yours insofar as a future involving harness racing is concerned.

"I suppose you could say that. Much like me, he has loved horse racing from the first time he was exposed to it. He has a great love of horses themselves and he enjoys going to the races and handicapping them. He is pretty good at doing so. I try to get to the Hambletonian and the Jug each year. He always comes with me and it has been a great source of father/son bonding. Nicholas, like his father, graduated from Humber College with an honors degree in journalism. He is already a published author and also a handicapper with a following. I hope that he can benefit from the errors I've made and build on the good things I've done. One thing that I think he sees and tries to emulate is my strong work ethic. Nothing I have in this business was given to me. My motto is something like: work hard. Then work harder. Then work harder still and don't say no to work. Good things can and will happen as they have for me. I feel blessed to work in this industry that I love and I never mail it in. I think I produce consistently good work that I am proud of, and I am already seeing that with Nicholas. He makes me proud every day."s

How opportunity knocked for Texsong Soprano and Joe Yoder

The owner astutely plucked the trotting colt with the strong maternal line from last year's Northern Indiana Yearling Speed Sale for just \$9,000. Texsong Soprano has

already earned nearly 10 times that amount.



Joe Yoder did not anticipate leaving last September's inaugural Northern Indiana Yearling Speed Sale with a horse. However, as a self-professed bargain hunter, he is accustomed to capitalizing on opportunities when presented. Today, he is reaping the rewards of such an opportunity. Texsong Soprano, a trotting colt he acquired at the Topeka, IN sale for \$9,000, has quickly accumulated \$87,222 in five career starts, the latest a 1:56.3 victory in Indiana Sires Stakes action at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino.

"I wasn't really in the market to buy any. I had a couple already. I'm always looking for a bargain, and he brought \$9,000 at the sale, so I consider that a bargain," Yoder said. "On the sire side, he's a Text Me. He wasn't well known yet, but I was always a Kadabra fan. The dam side really got me fired up."

Cataloged as Hip 33 in the sale last fall, Texsong Soprano is the ninth foal out of the unraced Muscles Yankee mare Muscling In. She is better known as the dam of 2010 O'Brien Award winning older trotting mare of the year Windsong Soprano. The colt's third dam is Armbro Blush, Dan Patch Award winner in the freshman trotting filly division in 1982, who also produced two-time O'Brien Award winner Armbro Leader.

"He was probably the best dam line in all the yearlings that went through the public sale ring in Indiana last year. His half-sister, Windsong Soprano, made \$1.2 million, and she produced a lot of good racehorses. So that caught my eye," he said.



With only 16 registered foals and five starters, Text Me offers a very small sample of progeny. Perhaps that was a factor that led to the colt not receiving more attention. His conformation may have been another factor.

I've got a pretty good chiropractor and I work them in a round pen. I wasn't too concerned about that because I thought I could fix it. If I wouldn't have done anything, he would have been a knee knocker."

Bred and sold by Abraham Miller, Texsong Soprano grew up an orphan. Muscling In was lost after foaling the colt. Raised on goat milk and milk replacer, Miller's children would play with the developing colt as if he were a family pet. The owner believes that close interaction made Texsong Soprano easy to work with around the barn.

Yoder, a Howe, IN resident, owns the colt with his son, Daryl. He trained down Texsong Soprano over the winter in northern Indiana. As he developed the young trotter on a straight track, Yoder realized very early that his charge was different.

"Early on, I knew this was going to be a special horse if we could keep him sound. Back in March he showed me a lot of talent already," the owner said. "He was kind of a really smart horse. Early on he drove like an old horse. He was just always easy to get along with, a highlight all along."

Once he felt Texsong Soprano was ready to qualify, he sent the horse to Joe Essig Jr. and Missy Essig. While he thought the colt was special, he wanted an honest assessment before preparing for pari-mutuel action.

"The day that I took him down, I told Joe, 'I'm going to bring you a horse. I want you to be honest with me. When I come down there, if you don't like the horse, you're not going to hurt my feelings. Tell me right away," Yoder recalled of the exchange with Essig. "We went out with two horses and completed a training trip. We turned around and I asked, 'What do you think?' He said, 'Joe, this makes your hair stand on end.' That's just kind of the way the horse is. He's playful, but when he's on the track, he's all horse.

To his credit, Texsong Soprano has shown he is all horse each time he lines up behind the starting gate. After a pair of qualifiers – a win and runner-up performance – he claimed victory in his pari-mutuel debut, a 1:57 clocking. Moving directly into Indiana Sires Stakes competition his next time out, the freshman romped by seven and one-quarter lengths in his \$46,500 division for driver Matt Krueger, stopping the clock in 1:55.3. Two weeks later he was nosed out in 1:55.1 by Jailhouse Dance in the second leg of sires stakes. Getting his first taste of Grand Circuit competition, the trotter finished in a dead-heat with Dash Of Luck for second in the \$45,797 Ralph Wilfong Memorial at the Indiana State Fair. His time of 1:57.3 was a tick slower than winner Just Show Up.

Texsong Soprano returned to the winner's circle Wednesday (Aug. 17) in the third round of Indiana Sires Stakes. Drawing post six in the night's 11th race, a \$67,500 split, John DeLong sat behind the favorite for the first time in competition. Biding



their time in third through a :58.4 opening half, the duo were out and challenging first up in the turn, taking control in the stretch and winning by two lengths with a 1:56.3 clocking. Yoder shared that he has fielded calls from interested parties trying to buy Texsong Soprano.

"I had a couple people try to buy him. I'm not saying I wouldn't sell if the price is right. At this point, I'm not looking to sell. I'm just enjoying the experience," he said.

Wednesday's second division was claimed by Bourbon Courage, a You Know You Do half-brother to Hambletonian champion Captain Corey, who trotted the mile in 1:56. Trained by Erv Miller, the colt brought \$255,000 at last fall's Hoosier Classic sale, making him the highest-priced Indiana-sired yearling to sell at public auction. Texsong Soprano and Bourbon Courage have yet to draw into the same division together. Yoder knows it is inevitable, and looks forward to the challenge.

"Once they leave that ring, I don't care if you pay \$200,000 or \$5,000, they're all on the same level," Yoder said. "It's going to be fun racing against him. We haven't met yet. John (DeLong) is driving our horse now. I think he's the right fit for the horse. It's going to be interesting."

Joe Yoder was not searching for a yearling in Topeka last September. Nevertheless, through fate or just plain luck, he found a trotter that is developing into something really special.

Of Brian Brown and a paid assassin

Having read an interesting piece about a 3-year-old pacing filly named Trick Of The Light, I compulsively ran her five-generation pedigree on the USTA's Pathway. But before we look at that, a word about two of the people responsible for this filly who already has a record at 3 of 1:50 and earnings of \$362,150.

Trick Of The Light is trained by Brian Brown, who to me is one of our sport's best kept secrets when it comes to top trainers. His home base is somewhere in Ohio, where he does a lot of damage in the sire stakes there, but he more than holds his own on the biggest stage of our sport, with wins in both the Jugette and the Breeders Crown.


It's not my purpose to write ads for either horses or trainers, but as an objective observer, I regard Brown as an under-tapped resource when it comes to top trainers.

Back to Brown's filly, Trick Of The Light, she's by Odds On Equuleus and out of Gordjus, by Dragon Again. (Just say her dam's name out loud and you'll see it's a clever spelling of a very complimentary adjective).

Odds On Equuleus is owned by Dana Parham, whom I have gotten to know and am proud to claim as a friend. For 15 years, Parham and his group bet \$50 million or more every year on harness races. From this fact alone it is obvious he is more knowledgeable about betting on harness races than anyone else alive today.

Parham is also, as I soon found out, totally open to sharing his expertise with anyone who asks him a question. To the eternal shame of the people running our racetracks, not one of them has ever broached a question to Parham, or asked for his advice. I know that some tracks are owned by casino outfits that would like to be shut of harness racing, but that isn't all of them.

The Meadowlands is an example of a non-casino owned racetrack that could benefit tremendously from Parham's



advice. But for some reason inexplicable to me, when I tried to play the cupid who brought the two together, I got nowhere because that track wasn't sufficiently interested. For the good of all of us who depend on The Meadowlands as our primary source of light, I hope track owner Jeff Gural will reconsider and tap into Parham's vast betting knowledge.

THOUGHTS ON PRODUCING WINNING YEARLING VIDEOS

With the big yearling sales looming ahead, this is the prime time for making yearling videos. Here, a few observations from more than 60 years of selling yearlings.

Before they're videoed, every yearling should be shod in front and barefoot behind. For both trotters and pacers I use a 5/8's half round shoe in front. You want a high angle, say close to 50 degrees, in front, and a much lower angle, say 46 or 47 degrees, behind.

I video both trotters and pacers on the trot, and I think that's now a common practice. From all my years with Howard Beissinger, I'm sure I could put our occasional pacing yearling on the pace, but I doubt it would make an impression on the buyers that would justify the effort.

For anyone who wants to give it a try, leave the yearling barefoot in front and shod with a side-weighted shoe behind. It would also be helpful to fit a pair of hobbles on the yearling in the stall and, if possible, lead him or her with them on. Once they hit a pace, they'll stay with it sans the hobbles.

I also always video with a new pair of bright white rubber bell boots on in front. The boots will accentuate the yearling's action in front, and their little bit of weight will help him or her stay on the trot. Why everybody doesn't use them is a profound mystery to me.

Then there's the question about music on the video. To me it's a distraction, but I'm not everyone. I would point out that our biggest farm, Hanover, does shoe its yearlings in front, does put rubber bell boots on in front, and doesn't have any music.

REMEMBERING FORREST SKIPPER

Finally, I happened to read the name Forrest Bartlett in a news item. It brought back memories from 35 years ago when Mr. Bartlett came up with a good pacer named Forrest Skipper.

When Forrest Skipper was a 6-year-old, in 1986, Lou Guida got involved with him. The horse was trained and driven by Lucien Fontaine, and the goal his connections, Guide and Loosh, set for themselves was an undefeated season and then rewarded by being voted Horse of the Year.

Their only problem was a 2-year-old pacing colt named Jate Lobell, who was in the first crop by No Nukes, standing at my farm, Lana Lobell.

Forrest Skipper did go undefeated that season, although it required Loosh to scratch him while he was in the race paddock at some track in Canada. That happened because minutes before the race was called, one of the other drivers told Fontaine, or Loosh as we all knew him, that he intended to park him every step of the mile.

Thinking fast, Loosh rushed up to the paddock judge to tell him his horse had suddenly developed a high fever, lameness in all four legs, was about to founder, and had contracted several highly communicable and often fatal diseases.

It worked, and the judges scratched Forrest Skipper. Who miraculously recovered in time for Fontaine to work him a fast mile that same night before he left the paddock.

Meanwhile, all of us at Lana Lobell were pulling hard for Jate Lobell to be voted Horse of the Year, for the benefit of our new pacing sire, No Nukes.

As I remember, Jate Lobell was also undefeated, but he hadn't gotten the kind of ink Guida had drummed up for Forrest Skipper. At the time my right hand man was Steve Katz, a wonderful guy who among many other talents was a good writer. So when some

publication asked Katz to do a piece about Jate Lobell and why he deserved to be Horse of the Year, he gave them a well written, objective statement stating all the points in Jate Lobell's favor.


Guida responded with a blast in which he called Katz a paid assassin. Which still brings a smile to my face, because anyone who knew Katz knew that in any encounter with a fly, your best bet would be on the fly.

And my paid assassin is still living peacefully, and I wish him all the best for many years to come.

N.B.

For the record, the 1986 Harness Horse of the Year was Forrest Skipper. Upon retirement from racing, he entered stud at a farm in New Jersey for a fee of only \$5,000, remarkably low for a Horse of the Year. He was unsuccessful as a sire here, and wound up standing in New Zealand, where he also left no lasting impression. On the contrary, his rival, Jate Lobell, went on to be one of the very best pacing sires in North American.







Grant Dixon just the fourth to top 5,000 driving wins in the southern hemisphere

It is so typical of Grant Dixon's modesty and unassuming nature that he doesn't feel comfortable talking much about his latest remarkable achievement.

The champion Queensland horseman became just the fourth driver in the southern hemisphere to top 5,000 career wins when he saluted on stable favourite Colt Thirty One on Aug. 13 at Albion Park.

It propelled the 49-year-old Dixon into truly elite company. Chris Alford leads the way with more than 7,700 wins, the late Gavin Lang reached 6,303 and veteran WA superstar Chris Lewis is nearing 6,000.

"It is amazing to be up with those guys, but it doesn't feel quite right," Dixon said. "I've won most of my races up here

in Queensland, while they've won everywhere and won Inter Dominions and major Group 1 races all over the place.

"I guess that's the only disappointing part to me, that I haven't had the horses or opportunities to win those sorts of races."

All that could be set to change in the next couple of years, but more on that later.

In a script fitting of a TV show, Dixon brought-up his milestone win on Colt Thirty One when the 6-year-old turned his form around to post the 51st win of his stellar career, which has netted over \$A1 million in earnings.

"It was like old Chester (Colt Thirty One) knew the significance of the night and the race," Dixon said.

"He'd been down on form for while and we didn't think he could win. He had a hard run and when he'd normally be feeling the pinch, he really dug in. I could feel him really lift halfway down the straight. It's the best he's felt in a long time, and it made it extra special.

"Chester's the most special horse we've had. He and a horse called Majestic Mach, who looked like being anything as a young horse, but didn't quite go on with it as much as we hoped when he got older."

Dixon's milestone is even more remarkable and special to him given the major health scare he was confronted with in 2013.

"I had this bad cold I just couldn't shake. Majestic Mach was in the Sires' final on the Saturday night, and I didn't want to miss driving him, so I went to the doctor on the Tuesday. He took some blood tests," Dixon said.

"The next day the phone rang, I saw it was the doctor's number, and thought 'Oh, this can't be good.' He told me to get straight to the (Brisbane) hospital because I had Leukemia and needed to go straight for treatment immediately.

Harness Racing Update

"I was hooked-up to a machine for three hours a day for the next 10 days straight.

"I was so flat, but I asked him if I could pop out of hospital just for one drive – Majestic Mach in that final. He said he wouldn't recommend it, but also wouldn't stop me. I drove in the race, but gee it knocked me around because my red (blood) cell count was so low."

Dixon's form of Leukemia is CML (Chronic Myeloid Leukemia) and, after the initial blood transfusions, it is treatable with ongoing medication.

"I'm lucky, very lucky. It's the best type of Leukemia to get, if that makes sense," he said. "It's pretty much stayed under control since with medication. I see the specialist once every three months and keep dealing with it."

Dixon is in awe of his wife of almost 12 years, Trista, who not only runs the huge stable of 60 horses in work, but is also mother to their three children: Thomas 9, Jai 7 and Cooper 2.

"She's a marvel. She works harder than me, way, way harder," he said. "It was just before we had Thomas when I got sick, and Trista's had to shoulder everything along the way.

"We'd have runners at four or five meetings every week and I'd drive at four. I used to drive at five or six, but I make time to spend with the kids now. I listen to those self-help podcasts and there's not a successful person you listen to who doesn't say they wished they carved out more time to spend with their kids."

Dixon started driving in 1988, not long after his hugely successful and late father, Bill, had moved the family down from Townsville in northern Queensland to the big smoke in Brisbane to try and take his training career to another level.

"Dad was a great support and huge inspiration," Grant said. "It took me a bit of time to get ticking when I first started driving. I'd say it was a slow, gradual climb."

Back to Dixon's lament about a scarcity of interstate or feature race opportunities and in an already special year, he looks to have found the best pacer he has trained yet, 3-year-old Leap To Fame.

The son of Bettors Delight has looked awesome winning 12 of his 17 starts, including the Group 1 NSW and Queensland Derbys.

Leap To Fame has already won an interstate feature with the NSW Derby triumph in March, but Dixon hopes it is just entrée to the coming months and years.

"He's potentially the best yet. I say potentially because Majestic Mach and Colt Thirty One were fantastic young horses and raced against really, really good crops. Majestic Mach was beaten by Lennytheshark in a NSW Derby and he went on to win an Inter Dominion. King Of Swing beat Colt Thirty One in the 2YO Breeders Crown and he won three Miracle Miles.

"Leap To Fame feels special and has looked great so far, but his test will come in the next few months when we head to Victoria."

Leap To Fame is trying to become the first pacer since Captain Joy in 2005 to win the NSW, Queensland Victoria Derbys.

The heats of the Victoria Derby are at Melton on Oct. 1 and the final a week later.

Beyond that, the powerfully-built colt has got the Breeders Crown series in Victoria in November and then a trip to Sydney for the NSW Breeders Challenge.

Then, next year, there are races like the Chariots Of Fire, Miracle Mile and the inaugural running of the world's richest race, the \$A2.1 million Eureka in Sydney next September.

"We'll meet some really talented horses in Victoria," Dixon said. "It'll definitely be a step-up from what he's been beating so far."

Horses such as Catch A Wave, who boasts nine wins from just 10 starts, and Kiwi raider Akuta, who is considered one "right out of the box" by New Zealand experts.

"I'm not saying and certainly not assuming he'll beat those horses, but he has got X-factor this horse. I had to really ask him for the ultimate effort, that bit extra, for the first time in the Queensland Derby last time and he found for me. Only special horses can do that," Dixon said.

Cinema standardbred: a plot to promote the sport of harness racing - Part 3

Alternative Actions (AA) continues its series developed to offer the solution that has the best chance to change the nature of the film industry's ambivalence towards harness racing and perhaps inspire someone to pioneer a project that could be the most successful promotional tool standardbred racing ever utilized.

In 1956, Hollywood symbolically murdered horse racing as a relevant scenario for any genre of film with the United Artists release of a dark crime drama titled "The Killing." Though I doubt if young screenwriter/director Stanley Kubrick had any such goal in mind, his interpretation of Lionel White's novel delivered a blatant metaphor that there will always be greener pastures for screen stories to be placed upon than racetracks featuring any animal breed.

The film title itself is a metaphor (the novel's title was "Clean Break"); a killing is slang for a successful, robust crime. Plot-wise, pulling off the story's killing involves a dramatic distraction — the assassination of a thoroughbred while it is racing

The gang leader concocts the robbery of \$2 million, which he measures as one day's expected total receipts from fictional Lansdowne Racetrack (filmed at Bay Meadows in San Mateo, CA). He hires a rifle sharpshooter and gives him specific instructions: he must pull the trigger and shoot to kill the horse leading around the first turn in the high-level stakes race featured on the racing program. (The audience can only speculate the gang leader is also a handicapper). While instructing the shooter, the gang leader closes the deal by convincing the gunman the task is no big deal and it might not even get him in trouble if caught.

"You shot a horse," the gang leader says. "It isn't first-degree murder, in fact it isn't even murder, in fact, I don't know what it is."

A critic wrote that "The Killing" was "a perfect film with the perfect cast, the perfect script, perfect dialogue, perfect

performances and perfect direction." It was also a perfect subconscious message of doom for screenplays: Horse racing in a movie script as a backdrop or an immediate stage is toxic.

THE WRITE STUFF

Horses themselves were not considered toxic in movies, however. With television as a second platform, movie studios continued to generate product based upon what trended in pop-culture. Major Hollywood movie companies as well as up-and-coming independent ones gave horses plenty of work in the 1950s and '60s, mostly because horses were imperative elements for productions involving the big TV trend of those decades--Westerns.

Western-oriented screenplays needed horses and sometimes made popular characters out of some. Still, the likes of Trigger, Silver and Flicka were second bananas to the actors playing The Lone Ranger, The Range Rider, Annie Oakley and Cheyenne. Even John Wayne, already a major star, overshadowed his stallion and stole the name of his horse, Duke.

At the same time at raceways across North America, harness racing was covered daily in the sports sections of newspapers but the community of standardbreds had no business in screenplays. Even though popular actors praised standardbreds and supported the sport were uninterested and in no position to experiment writing a movie where newsworthy trotters and pacers Bye Bye Bird, Nevele Pride or three-time Harness Horse of the Year Bret Hanover performed.

James Cagney admitted his love of standardbreds in his autobiography "Cagney On Cagney." The Oscar-winning actor owned and drove harness horses as a hobby and trained them on his Massachusetts farm. He wrote about the beauty of them. "I cry at horse races where I look at total effort," he said. Cagney could have commissioned a script addressing the theme of his affection for the horse in harness but retired and left Hollywood behind.

Mickey Rooney is well known later in his career for playing a race-torn jockey in the adaptation of Walter Farley's "The Black Stallion." Rooney loved standardbreds (I saw him often at Hollywood Park) but even with that film's success nothing happened concerning a standardbred-oriented story.

A fascinating sidebar to that movie is the emerged stardom of the main horse in the title role (there were four horses in all). It was a Texas-bred Arabian named Cass Ole. He toured many racetracks as a promotion for the film. I met Cass Ole in the 1980s at Longacres Racetrack in Seattle and I learned his white legs and a star on one were painted black for his role.

In Part 4 of this series I address the standardbred-screenplay predicament, how it misfired and can be solved.

Would you participate in this draft?

Xander B. Hypothetical, aka the X-Man, decided to experiment in Ohio. He purchased fifty Ohio-eligible yearlings, twenty-five pacers, and twenty-five trotters. He also purchased four more as insurance in case of injury or illness. He bought these yearlings through the sales ring as usual. However, the unusual angle was that X-Man purchased these yearlings, all of them, for remarketing.

The bulk of the yearlings X-Man purchased sold in the \$20,000-\$30,000 range. A handful sold for considerably more, including a sales topper, while another handful sold for less than twenty thousand dollars. Most yearlings temporarily returned to the farms of the consignors, and others warehoused at a nearby farm. These sales were a busy time for X-Man.

The sales companies and individual yearling cosigners were pleased with the enthusiastic new bidder in the audience because sales prices increased with each of his bids. The day after purchasing his final Ohio-eligible yearling, X-Man created two lists for a pair of drafts, one for trotters and one for pacers. He planned to model them after the drafts held in other professional sports.

The list of yearlings in his draft appeared online, two simple pools of horses (there would not be sufficient time to compose and mail a paper catalog). The Spectacular First Annual X-Man Draft of Remarketed Prospects, Sleepers, and Suspects Yearlings was about to begin.

Below the list of yearlings that he posted; he explained his draft plan:

"If you wish to participate in this draft, you will need to pay \$25,000 for a slot before noon on Dec. 1. The company will assume any yearling slots if less than 25 slots sell. There will be a drawing if more than 25 applicants apply for the draft slots. Each draft slot guarantees the purchaser will receive one of the 25 yearlings. You may purchase more than one slot, but a maximum of four.

"Participants can access prior sales prices at public auctions, videos, and pedigree pages.

"On Dec. 3, there will be a live-stream drawing for draft slots. This random drawing will be exciting and dramatic. At 2 p.m., a large board numbered 1 -25 (trotter division) will be filled with names drawn from a large bid of 25 identical plastic eggs. Drawing will continue until all slots fill. The board could look like this:

1st pick, Rick Butterfield, text 440 923 -7766

2nd pick, Myra Copperfield, text 678 934 -8865

3rd pick, The Sandbag Foursome Group, text 552 345-9112 Etc.

"The official draft day will be Dec. at 2 p.m. (trotters) and 4 p.m. (pacers). All horses will be on the grounds by 10 a.m. You will be responsible for having a representative in the crowd to make the selection, be interviewed after the draft, and arrange transportation from the sales location. USTA representatives shall be on the premises for title transfers.

"After perusing the lists, you will believe some of these yearlings are well worth \$25,000 and others are not. It is feasible that an early draft pick will give you access to a yearling valued at more than the slot fee you pony up, possibly much more, and of course, you may draw the last selection in the draft and end up with a yearling that you might not love. But nothing is certain. Individuals with later draft choices will have options. Everyone has options."

Like drafts in other professional sports, you can be passive or active if you have a slot in the draft. You can merely hold onto your high draft choice or trade it. It is your draft slot. You could also trade your third draft slot to someone for two of their lower slots. You could resell. The possibilities are endless and intriguing, and the action can last until the moment the final draft pick comes off the board.

Draft day is exciting. Who will take what horse off the board? Who will be the best choice remaining when slot holders make their selection? Who will move up or down or trade or buy or sell? What a wild ride. What a great show. What a buzz.

Would you purchase a slot?

Rollin Rosie and Jordan Ross roll in ISS at Harrah's Hoosier Park

Rollin Rosie made her Indiana Sires Stakes debut a winning one as she captured the lone \$134,000 Indiana Sires Stakes division for 2-year-old pacing fillies on the card at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino on Thursday (Aug. 18). With driver Jordan Ross in the bike, Rollin Rosie stopped the timer in 1:51.3 to establish a new lifetime best and give driver Jordan Ross the biggest win of his young driving career.

Leaving from post six in the field of 10, Ross sent Rollie Rosie away from the gate for position but would yield the lead to

Polks Image and Peter Wrenn through the opening quarter in :26.4. Rollin Rosie was content with a pocket trip and when the field reached the second station in :55, Trace Tetrick had his undefeated filly, JKs Lucky Lou, on the front.

Turning for home, JKs Lucky Lou was still calling the shots, but Beauty N Grace and Atlee Bender were applying pressure from first-over. With the top pair battling it out, Ross was able to find late racing room and Rollin Rosie responded with a :27.3 final quarter to track down JKs Lucky Lou and Beauty N Grace. Rollin Rosie finished three lengths in front of Beauty N Grace while Jks Lucky Lou held on for third. Rollin Rosie returned \$17.00 to her backers at the betting window for the slight upset.

Trained by Tyler George, Rollin Rosie remains undefeated in three starts this season. The daughter of JK Endofanera—Rock N Roll Baby is owned in partnership by Scp Stables, Tyler George and Gregory Samples. With the victory, Rollin Rosie pushed her lifetime bankroll to \$76,500.

"I didn't give Jordan any instructions before the race," George said after the victory. "I told him that she is a nice filly but don't get her too excited and do whatever you think is best. He did a nice job with her and she raced great."

The \$134,000 event marked the biggest purse win of Ross's young driving career. Ross is currently among the top 15 drivers at Harrah's Hoosier Park in 2022 with 25 wins on the season.



FRESHMAN PACING COLTS DELIVER FIREWORKS

Indiana Sire Stakes action continued on Friday (Aug. 19) at Harrah's Hoosier Park, with two \$68,000 divisions for the 2-year-old-pacing colts and geldings highlighting the 14-race card. It was leg three of six for the freshman pacing colts as they look to secure crucial points for the \$250,000 Indiana Sire Stakes Super Finals on Oct. 14.

In the first division going off as race 10 on the card, **Buzzsaw Russ** would reward the betting public's backing as the 2-5 choice. Leaving from post position three, John De Long hustled Buzzsaw Russ into the pocket position as Art It Is and Brandon Bates took the field to the quarter in a solid :27. Art It Is remained unchallenged on the engine through a half of :56.1 before Trace Tetrick hustled the Fox Stake Champion, Coach Stefanos into the mix first over to the leader's wheel at three quarters in 1:23.4.

In the stretch, Coach Stefanos and Tetrick forged to the lead as Buzzsaw Russ and De Long patiently waited for the passing lane. Buzzsaw Russ would explode up the rail in the final eighth to track down Coach Stefanos in the shadow of the wire and score the victory in a lifetime best 1:51.1. Art It Is would hold for third to round out the trifecta.

It was the third victory in four career starts for the Missy Essig trained gelding by Rockin Image out of the Yankee Cruiser mare, Up Front Cruiser. Bred by Devon Beech and Devon Knepp, Buzzsaw Russ has now banked \$84,160 for owners Russell Beeman and Charles Weaver.

In the second division in the evening's twelfth race, it would be **Flirtin JK** and Ricky Macomber Jr. turning in an impressive effort to pull off the upset 12-1. Leaving from post six, Flirtin JK would get away fifth in the field of seven as Trace Tetrick guided the heavily favored and unbeaten J B Gram to the front at the quarter in :28. J B Gram maintained his lead through a half of :56 before leading the field to three-quarters in 1:24.2 as Flirtin JK and Macomber launched their bid from fourth on the far turn six lengths behind the leader.

In the lane, Flirtin JK used a :26.3 final quarter to gobble up ground and make up the deficit, joining J B Gram on the lead late in the lane before getting up by a length and a quarter on the line to score in 1:52.1. J B Gram would hold for second, Adam Twelve and Joey Putnam finished third.

Trained and co-owned by Jamie Macomber who co-owns the gelding alongside the gelding's breeder James Stonecipher, Flirtin JK picked up his second win in five career starts and has now earned \$54,470. The 1:52.1 time was a lifetime best for the gelded son of JK Endofanera out of the McArdle mare, Mcflirty.

Also in action on the Friday night card, Tellmeaboutit bounced back a week after a ninth place effort in the \$315,000 Dan Patch Stakes to Bulldog Hanover, with an eye-popping 1:47.4 frontend score in the \$22,000 open pace with Mike Oosting aboard. Little Rocket Man and John De Long would rally for second, with Mac's Big Boy and Trace Tetrick finishing third.

The 1:47.4 effort was a lifetime best for the two-time Indiana Sire Stakes Champion son of Tellitlikeitis who has now pushed his gaudy career bankroll to \$743,065 for owners Twila Harts and Alvin Miller who trains the six-year-old gelding. The 1:47:4 time is the fastest mile of the 2022 meet thus far at Harrah's Hoosier Park surpassing the 1:48 mark previously held by Sectionline Bigry.







Annapolis Hanover sails to fifth straight win, takes PASS at The Meadows

Annapolis Hanover quarter-poled to the point, then cruised to his fifth straight victory — and third in Pennsylvania Sires Stake competition — in Friday's \$80,309 PASS at Hollywood Casino at The Meadows. **Fulton** captured the other division in the event, known as the Tyler B, for freshman colt and gelding pacers.

A \$15,000 yearling acquisition for owner/trainer Mitchell York, Annapolis Hanover has been untouchable since a third-place PASS finish on July 2. In the Tyler B, he blitzed the back half in :54.2 for Tim Tetrick to defeat the pocket-sitting Ervin Hanover by 4-3/4 lengths in a career-best 1:50.4. Ken Hanover was third.

York said he has no regrets about gelding the son of Stay Hungry—All Night Long.

"He was very studdy, and we're not set up for that. Typically we make the appointment to cut them on our way home from the sale," York said of Annapolis Hanover, who lifted his bankroll to

\$157,328. "He has one race after the PASS championship, then he's done for the year. We hope to put away a fresh horse and come back with a fresh horse next year."

Fulton passed up an early tuck, grabbed the lead and steamed home in 1:50.2, a lifetime mark, for Dave Palone, trainer Linda Toscano and owners Let It Ride Stables and Bottom Line Racing LLC. Lyons Surfing was second, beaten 1-3/4 lengths, with Bugaboo Lou third.

"I really liked my colt, and I think he'd rather race on the lead," Palone said of his early-race decision. "I wanted to make them bring it to him. When I kicked the plugs out in the last turn, he just responded. He's got a good future."

A son of Heston Blue Chip—Better Be Steamin, Fulton has been in the money in all six career starts, banking \$106.917.

STALLION SERIES

Lyons Stealth won his third stallion series split, scoring by 3-1/4 lengths in 1:52.1 as the 1-5 favorite. Just Bet It All and Mayweather Hanover took the other divisions.

Tetrick, who drove Lyons Stealth, called him a "classic 'tweener."

"He has the talent, and he's light on his feet," Tetrick said. "But mentally, he hasn't figured out how to get it done against horses that are slightly better. I think he'll come back stronger at 3."

Jim King, Jr. conditions the son of Sweet Lou—Zane Hanover for Threelyonsracing.

Palone piloted four winners and Tetrick three on the 12-race card.

Stockade Seelster remains the OSS freshman pacing colt king

Stockade Seelster stretched his flawless streak to five with an effortless win in the lone \$158,100 Ontario Sires Stakes Gold Series division on Friday (Aug. 19) at Woodbine Mohawk.

The son of State Treasurer was sharp off the gate, leading the field of eight 2-year-old pacing colts and geldings to a :26.3 opening quarter. Driver Jody Jamieson of Guelph, ON encouraged Stockade Seelster to ease up down the backstretch, and the fan favorites reached the half in :55.4.

Coop A Loop launched a challenge up the outer lane, but Stockade Seelster was comfortably in hand through the 1:24.2 three-quarters and cruised home a one length winner in 1:52. Ace Of Aces closed well to be second and two-time Gold Series winner Write Me A Rose was third.

"It's always nice to have the opportunity to train a son or a daughter of a good horse that you had years ago," said trainer Dr. Ian Moore, who guided State Treasurer through his \$2 million career. The Cambridge, ON resident added that, through the early stages of his career, Stockade Seelster has a great deal in common with his sire. "He got real aggressive after two races and his father did the same, but this guy is a fairly intelligent colt.

His father was kind of a bit of a runaway at the end of his 2-year-old year, but this guy seems to be coming around.

"Jody has done well with him. He was aggressive again tonight in the race. (Jamieson) couldn't really put him in a hole, but he did kind of come back to him in the third quarter, that's what he said. He was all fire up to the half and then he came back to him in the third quarter."

For his part, Jamieson has been impressed with Stockade Seelster through the first two months of the 2-year-old pacing colt season and has high hopes for his prospects in the weeks ahead, which feature not just Ontario Sires Stakes Gold

Series events, but open stake action against the best freshman pacing colts in North America.

After a few days of well-earned rest this week, Stockade Seelster will resume training in preparation for the third Gold Leg, on Sept. 3 at Woodbine Mohawk Park. Following that outing the colt will compete in the Champlain Stakes on Sept. 10 and the Metro Pace eliminations on Sept. 17, with hopes of advancing to the \$850,000 final on Sept. 24. The Gold Series regular season wraps up on Oct. 2 at Flamboro Downs and the \$225,000 Super Final, for the top 10 Gold Series point earners, is at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Oct. 15.

"That's what we're kind of striving for at this point but, like any 2-year-old, they're always day-to-day and week-to-week. You make plans, but 2-year-olds often disrupt those plans," said Dr. Moore. "But no matter what happens, he's got close to a quarter million made this year now and we're very, very pleased. His owners were all there tonight. Sally and Allan MacDonald came up from PEI and Paul MacDonald and Sophie were here as well."

Souris, PEI resident Sally MacDonald and Toronto, ON resident Paul MacDonald signed the buyers slip for Stockade Seelster at last fall's London Virtual Yearling Sale, offering up \$45,000 for the second foal of \$237,882 winner Soiree Seelster. Through three wins in Gold Series action and a win in one leg and the final of the Dream Maker Series, Stockade Seelster has earned \$237,600.
