Manchego defeats Atlanta in Casual Breeze showdown

The result was a 1:51.4 stakes record performance that equalled the Canadian and track record at Woodbine Mohawk Park.


Hambletonian Oaks champion Manchego delivered a stunning 1:51.4 stakes record performance to defeat Hambletonian champion Atlanta in Friday's \$136,000 Casual Breeze at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The superstar fillies were squaring off for the first time in 2018 and went off as co-favorites at odds of 4-5 in a field of 10.

Manchego and driver Yannick Gingras left strong from post eight, while Atlanta and driver Scott Zeron showed their usual early speed from post three. Driver Trevor Henry decided to mix things by firing longshot Smoke And Mirrors towards the lead and kept Manchego out going around the

first turn, as Zeron took back to settle third.

The Jimmy Takter-trained Manchego cleared to the top just strides after leading by three-quarters of a length at the opening-quarter in :27.3. The Hambletonian Oaks champion continued to trot strong for the next eighth of a mile before Gingras tapped the breaks to grab a comfortable :28.4 second quarter.

Atlanta was angled from the three-hole heading into the far turn, while Gingras and Manchego began to ramp up the tempo. Smoke And Mirrors gapped in the two-hole, which allowed Zeron to drop in with Atlanta and power up for the stretch battle.

Manchego reached three-quarters in 1:24.1 with a length-and-a-half lead on Atlanta.

In the stretch, Manchego continued her powerful ways and didn't allow Atlanta to get any closer than her wheel. The Takter trainee trotted a :27.3 final quarter to defeat Atlanta

by a length and three-quarters in a Canadian record equaling 1:51.4.

Friday's matchup between Manchego and Atlanta was months in the making. Manchego entered the season as the top filly after an undefeated rookie campaign. Atlanta made an immediate impact to start her sophomore season and eventually successfully took on the boys in the Hambletonian, while Manchego beat the fillies in the Oaks.

"Everybody was talking about Atlanta and rightfully so, she's a great filly too, but I never lost confidence in mine and all along I thought I had the best filly," said Gingras following the victory. "It's just one matchup... they'll meet up again many times, but my filly was super strong tonight."

Sorceress Seelster, who sat fourth most of the mile, finished 11 lengths back in third, while Blonde Magic was 12 lengths behind the winner in fourth.

Gingras noted in the winner's circle that the race didn't

play out like he imagined but didn't think the outcome would've been any different with opposite trips.

"I thought I would maybe get away second behind him, but of course when I was able to grab the lead I was happy about that. I think either way, at least tonight, even if he cut the mile I'd had beat him anyway."

A daughter of Muscle Hill—Secret Magic, Manchego improved to 18 wins and over \$1.4 million earned in 21 career starts for owners Black Horse Racing, John Fielding and Herb Liverman. She has now won six of nine this season and remains undefeated in three starts at Mohawk Park.

Rick Zeron trainee Atlanta suffered just her second loss in eight starts this season. The Chapter Seven—Hemi Blue Chip's filly's only prior defeat was a second in the first heat of the Hambletonian, which she followed up with an impressive victory in the final.

Manchego and Atlanta are both eligible to next Friday's Simcoe Stakes, which is followed by the Elegantimage Stakes eliminations on Sept. 8. Competing in all three events would

mean four consecutive weeks of racing, leaving a strong possibility one or both could skip next week's event.

A \$2 win ticket on Manchego returned \$3.60.

Live racing continues tonight at Woodbine Mohawk Park. The Maple Leaf Trot eliminations, Nassagaweya Stakes and Eternal Camnation Stakes headline an outstanding 13-race program. Post time is 7:10 p.m.





The new trend is one and done

The trend is now winning once in heat events and coming out with the title. Check out some of the recent big events:

In the 2017 Little Brown Jug, Filibuster Hanover was second in the first heat at 7-1 then first in the deciding heat at 5-1.

In the 2017 Kentucky Futurity, Snowstorm Hanover was second in the first heat at 82-1 then first at 5-1.

In the 2017 Hambletonian, Perfect Spirit was third in the first heat at 11-1, then named the winner in the deciding heat at 7-1.

In the 2018 Hambletonian, Atlanta was just nipped a neck in the first elim in 1:50.1, then came back as the second choice (\$6.40) to take the final.

Remember that others did this when the eliminations were the week before. Muscle Massive was 2-5 and third in his prep in 2010 and then won the final at 6-1 upsetting Trotter of the Year Lucky Chucky.

Alf Palema in 1992 was 15-1 and second before winning it all at 3-1 the same day.

Glidemaster was second at 5-2 in 2006 before uncorking a then Hambletonian best 1:51.1 en route to the Triple Crown at odds of 6-1.

Windsongs Legacy was the rare horse who won the Triple Crown and was not favored in either his elimination or final in 2004. The 8-5 second choice was third in the elimination, then a winner at 9-2 as the fourth choice.

Amigo Hall was third at 7-1 in 2003 then blew up the tote board at 27-1 in the final that year.

Quiz

Q. Who was the last person not named Bill Fahy to drive Western Hanover?

A. Jeff Fout. He drove Western Hanover to victory on Oct. 10, 1992 in a \$10,500 invitational handicap. (Western Hanover was 28 19-7-1 for the season with earnings of \$1,844,315).

Remembering Shelly Goudreau

Thirty-six years ago this August, Shelly Goudreau had his fatal accident in California. He died the first week of September. The talented 34-year-old had a unique record that can never be duplicated. He was the only driver who had appeared in every million-dollar race contested to that point — all six. His only on the board finish was with Armbro Wolf, who was just edged out by 69-1 Land Grant for the biggest ever prize in the 1980 Woodrow Wilson (\$2,011,000 purse).

Opening nights

The Meadowlands opened on Sept. 1, 1976. A crowd of 42,133 stormed the gates to welcome nighttime harness racing to New Jersey. Ray Remmen won the first race with Quick Baron in 1:57.2. Rambling Willie took the later feature in 1:55.2. The all-time New Jersey betting handle on track was smashed by the fifth race — \$1,363,014 was the record going into the night. By 11:15 that night, only seven races had been run. Forty-nine drivers were on the card. That same night, Yonkers drew 11,783 and Freehold had an attendance of 2,951 that day.

Roosevelt Raceway opened on Long Island, NY on Sept. 2, 1940. It rained all the last week of August and a horse shortage was alleviated due to the rain delays. Approximately 8,000 fans showed up for the opener. A total of \$40,862 went through the windows on night one, which was the introduction of nighttime harness racing to the Metropolitan area.

Melander hopes for 'Wow' factor in Maple Leaf Trot

Crazy Wow will make his first start for Marcus Melander in the first of tonight's two eliminations for the Maple Leaf Trot at Ontario's Woodbine Mohawk Park and the trainer is looking forward to seeing the 6-year-old stallion in action. Melander took over the conditioning of the career \$2.27-million-earner in early July.

A total of 16 older trotters, including defending champion Hannelore Hanover, entered the Maple Leaf Trot and were split into two eight-horse eliminations. The top-five finishers from each C\$40,000 division will return for the C\$651,000 final on Sept. 1 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Crazy Wow, trained previously by Ron Burke, will start from post three in his elimination with driver Tim Tetrick and is 5-1 on the morning line. Crazy Wow last raced June 30 and enters the elimination off a 1:55.2 win in a qualifier at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono on Aug. 15.

The elimination also includes Marion Marauder, Emoticon Hanover, I Know My Chip, Dancer Hall, Bill's Man, JL Cruze, and Pinkman. Marion Marauder is the 5-2 favorite followed by Dancer Hall, a C\$40,000 supplemental entrant, at 3-1.

"I'm very excited to see him race," Melander said about Crazy Wow. "It's only the first start for me; I don't really know what to expect from him after only one qualifier. I've been training him a lot, but the other horses are going into the race in full form. He's on his way up.

"Hopefully we can make the final because I think he will be much better in the final the week after. But I think he's ready to go with these horses. He hasn't raced for seven or eight weeks, he's not going to be on top of his game, but I think he will do a good race."

In the second Maple Leaf Trot elimination, Will Take Charge is the 5-2 favorite followed by Hannelore Hanover at 3-1. The division is completed by Odds On Amethyst, Warrawee Roo, Guardian Angel As, Il Sogno Dream, Ariana G, and Dunbar Hall.

Tonight's card also includes three divisions of the Nassagaweya Stakes for 2-year-old male pacers and three divisions of the Eternal Camnation Stakes for 2-year-old female pacers.

Crazy Wow is owned by Our Horse Cents Stables, Stable 45, J&T Silva Stables, and Deo Volente Farms. Melander trains multiple other horses for several of the partners.

A son of Crazed out of No Pan No Gain, Crazy Wow has won

21 of 64 career races and one of five this season. His win this season came in a preferred handicap at The Meadowlands. He finished third in the Arthur J. Cutler Memorial, behind Hannelore Hanover and Will Take Charge, and third in the Maxie Lee Memorial Invitational, behind Will Take Charge and Marion Marauder.

"He's a very nice horse to be around," Melander said. "Even though he's a stud, he's like a gelding to be around. He's a little lazy in training. I didn't know really where I had him before we qualified because at home he's very comfortable.

"In the qualifier, when we went behind the gate, he really stepped up. You could feel he was the racehorse you thought he would be. But at home he is very laid back."

Melander drove Crazy Wow in his qualifier.

"I always like to drive my horses in their first qualifier, at least," Melander said. "Especially if it's a new horse, so I can feel if I want to do any changes. I didn't really know what to expect from him in the qualifier, but it was a good qualifier. He went a (1):55 mile pretty good and I was happy with him."

Melander has spent the past several weeks getting to know Crazy Wow and tinkering with his equipment.

"We changed a little shoeing," Melander said. "I qualified him with an open bridle. I know he had cups before; maybe we put something on his head as well because he is very laid back. You try to do some changes, do what you think is best. Every trainer trains differently. We trained him the way we train our horses. It feels like he is happy.

"There are a lot of big races left, so I think he could have a good next couple of months."

Hannelore Hanover looking to defend

Defending Maple Leaf Trot champion **Hannelore Hanover** is back with her eyes set on another memorable victory at Woodbine Mohawk Park. The 6-year-old world champion is 11 for 12 lifetime at the Milton, ON racetrack and is looking for her third-consecutive appearance in the Maple Leaf Trot final.

Hannelore Hanover (PP5) is entering tonight's second Maple Leaf Trot elimination in similar fashion to last year's. The Ron Burke trained mare is currently on a two-race losing streak, which almost mirrors the three-consecutive losses she suffered prior to sweeping last year's event.

Regular driver Yannick Gingras will team up with the reigning Canadian and U.S. Horse of the Year.

Jeff Gillis trainee **Will Take Charge** (PP1, Tim Tetrick) has been red-hot and will line up in the same elimination as Hannelore Hanover. The 5-year-old is eight for 16 this season and coming in off a dominating 1:51.2 victory in the Crawford Farms at Tioga Downs on August 12.

Will Take Charge is nearing \$400,000 in earnings this season and currently sits at \$954,478 in career earnings.

Hannelore Hanover won't be the only mare lining up in tonight's second split.

Jimmy Takter trainee **Ariana G** (PP5, David Miller) will face the toughest test of her career. The winner of \$2.3 million is three for seven this season and like Hannelore Hanover, sports an impressive record of six wins in seven starts at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The first elimination is headlined by **Marion Marauder** (PP1, Scott Zeron), who has an opportunity to surpass \$3 million in career earnings.

The Paula Wellwood and Mike Keeling trained 5-year-old is just \$4,798 away from the \$3 million mark (by Canadian accounting) and would hit that milestone with a top-three finish in his elimination.

Marion Marauder is currently posting another outstanding season, sporting a record of four wins and three runner-up finishes in seven starts for \$316,494 earned.

The 2016 Trotting Triple Crown champion will be seeking redemption in this year's Maple Leaf Trot after a rare disappointing effort in last year's elimination saw him fail to make the final.

Marion Marauder's challengers in the first elimination include: **Emoticon Hanover** (PP2, Bob McClure), Crazy Wow (PP3, David Miller), **JL Cruze** (PP7, Brett Miller) and **Pinkman** (PP8, TBA), all winners of over \$1 million.

The eliminations for the Maple Leaf Trot have been carded as Races 3 and 5. Elimination winners earn the right to select their post for the final.

Post time for tonight's card is 7:10 p.m.

Schnittker hopes best is yet to come for Wild Bill in Messenger

After seeing Wild Bill suffer an injury at age 2 and from bleeding issues this year at 3, trainer Ray Schnittker hopes his colt is ready to turn the corner beginning in tonight's eliminations for the Messenger Stakes at Yonkers Raceway.

Wild Bill, a full brother to Dan Patch Award-winner Huntsville, adds Lasix for his upcoming race following off-the-board finishes in his past two starts. For his career, he has won

three of eight races and earned \$58,391 for Schnittker, who bred Wild Bill with the late Charlie Iannazzo and remains the owner of the colt.

"He hadn't been racing that well," Schnittker said. "We scoped him and he was bleeding pretty badly so we put him on Lasix. I think it's going to make a big difference. He trained very well on it and I think it'll be a factor. It seems like it really made a difference, but we're going to find out quickly on Saturday."

The Messenger Stakes is the second jewel in the Pacing Triple Crown. **Stay Hungry** won the first jewel, the Cane Pace, on Aug. 4 at The Meadowlands. The final jewel, the Little Brown Juq, is Sept. 20.

Stay Hungry and Wild Bill were among 11 horses entered in the Messenger. The top-four finishers from each of tonight's two \$40,000 eliminations advance to the \$500,000 final on Sept. 1 at Yonkers. Racing begins at 6:50 p.m. (EDT), with the Messenger eliminations as races five and six.

Wild Bill won the first two races of his career — including a Pennsylvania Sire Stakes division that included future open-stakes-winners Nutcracker Sweet, Hayden Hanover, and Dorsoduro Hanover — before consecutive fifth-place finishes that proved to be his final starts of the season.

"He got a leg injury so we had to quit with him," Schnittker said. "He came back a hundred percent on that."

Wild Bill is a son of Somebeachsomewhere out of Schnittker's mare Wild West Show, who has produced stakes winners Stevensville, Cowboy Terrier, Beachesofcheyenne, and Huntsville. In 2016, Huntsville paced

world-record-equaling

1:49 mile and was named best 2-year-old male pacer. In 2017, he won the Meadowlands Pace and Cane Pace before retiring in October because of injury. His best win time of the season, 1:47.4, led all 3-year-old pacers.

"He's definitely not Huntsville, but he's a pretty nice colt," Schnittker said about Wild Bill. "He's a lot smaller horse, but he's the same type of horse — he wants to go. He's just nice to drive, two fingers and does everything right. He's a little smarter horse probably than Huntsville. I don't know if he's as fast. I think I'd rather have fast than smart."

Wild Bill has a full stakes schedule ahead of him and Schnittker hopes the issues that have hampered the colt are things of the past.

"If he can put it together here a little bit, I'd be tickled to death if he could hit the board in the final, we'll see what happens," said Schnittker, who will drive Wild Bill tonight. "I'd be surprised if he's not kind of right there. I'm looking for a strong second half of the year."

Steacy sends out three in tonight's Eternal Camnation

Trainer Mark Steacy sends a trio of freshmen pacing fillies in tonight's \$251,347 Eternal Camnation Stakes at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Beach Bar, Tarryn A Strip and Abuelita Hanover race in the first, second and third divisions, respectively, and will look to make noise in Mohawk Park's first of several Grand Circuit events for 2-year-old pacing fillies.

"Usually I don't have that many pacing fillies," Steacy said.
"I've had one or two colts or one colt, one filly but never a group of three. I actually have an Ontario-bred that's not too bad, too, so we have four pretty nice pacing fillies."

Beach Bar starts the stakes evening for Steacy from post-eight in the \$84,116 first division of the Eternal Camnation. The daughter of Somebeachsomewhere has started from that same post in her last two starts, with her most recent resulting in an off the pace fourth-place finish in the \$37,000 Whenuwishuponastar.

"She's actually a handy little filly but she's been handicapped with the outside hole pretty much every start she's had so far including this week," Steacy said. "I'm not one to like to fire them in their first few races, too. I like to sit back and teach them how to come from behind, so I don't force my drivers to be too hard on them at the start of the race in their first three or four starts."

Driver Paul MacDonell, back in the bike for owners Robert and Shelly Macmillan and Frederick Hertrich III, sent Beach Bar for a top spot in her second start career and finished second by a neck.

"She's got his nice little brush to her — she seems to try real hard at the end," Steacy said. "She's probably the handiest of the three right now — she's the smallest, but probably the handiest. And I think she's the gutsiest of the three right at the moment."

Tarryn A Strip starts from post-three in the second division. She enters off a sixth-place finish in the Whenuwishuponastar final, which saw her suffer interference entering the backstretch from a halting leader.

"I think (the interference) hurt her a lot," Steacy said. "The horse (in front of her almost) made her come to a complete stop. We scoped her after and she did scope just a touch sick that day. So just (with) the combination of both, she just wasn't as good as she can be. She was quite good in her other starts and in her qualifiers so I expect a lot more from her this week."

Steacy noted that Tarryn A Strip seemed to clear up after being treat with antibiotics following her last start and trained well earlier this week.

"She trained (Wednesday) in 2:06 and she trained quite well; they all actually trained together and all three of them were very good. I think she's going into this race a lot healthier for sure."

Sylvain Filion, who drove the daughter of Captaintreacherous in her most recent start, sent Tarryn A Strip for the lead from the rail after the filly has raced her previous two starts from off the pace.

"She drew inside and Sylvain (Filion) had sat behind her the week before, so he just thought she could get away a lot better," Steacy said. "And he did that but it didn't work to her benefit since that horse stopped dead in front of him."

Steacy's final starter, Abuelita Hanover, races from the rail with MacDonald driving. Steacy also owns the daughter of Somebeachsomewhere with partners Hudson Standardbred Stable Inc. and Howard Pearce.

"I thought she was a nice-looking yearling when I bought her; good size," Steacy said. "I liked that (the broodmare) had a couple of Yankee Cruisers that sold for no money at all. I didn't know the horses, but they all turned out to be nice horses. So I was hoping that Somebeachsomewhere would step the mare up and that this girl would be much better.

"She broke really nice. She looked great on the trot (but) when I switched her to the pace she didn't respond very well — she crossfired, got on a shaft; she was really ill gaited for a while. But the farther she trained down, the better gaited she got and she had a lot more speed training down."

Abuelita Hanover avoided the interference in the Whenuwishuponastar. However, the filly veered wide and tracked cover from Key West to finish fourth in a dead heat with Beach Bar.

"She felt really good following," Steacy said. "She felt really strong going into the stretch. (James MacDonald) may have pulled her a little earlier than he probably had to but only because she felt so good, he said. When he did pull her out she kind of hung a little bit.

Steacy said Abuelita Hanover scoped with minor sickness two starts back in the second preliminary for the Whenuwishuponastar and placed her on antibiotics following that start.

"I was just thinking that she maybe was just not quite

cleared up," Steacy said of her performance in the Whenuwishuponastar. "When she qualified she was strong right through the wire and even in her first race she was strong through the wire. She was real strong training with the other two and was very powerful right through the wire. She drew a good post position so I'm hoping she steps up pretty good this week."

The three divisions of the Eternal Camnation go alongside three splits of the \$276,651 Nassagaweya Stakes for rookie pacers and two \$40,000 eliminations for the Maple Leaf Trot.

Post time for the 13-race card is set for 7:10 p.m.

David Miller guides pair of PA Stallion Series winners

Hall of Famer David Miller guided 2-year-old pacing fillies May Bride Hanover and Skater Chick to their third Pennsylvania Stallion Series victories on Thursday afternoon at Harrah's Philadelphia, each their third straight triumph after skipping the first leg, and he may have a hard decision to make as to which filly to guide in the group's Championship race here on Labor Day Monday.

Skater Chick, a daughter of Sweet Lou-Ram Rocker, had to do some fancy skating down the backstretch for Miller during her win. She was positioned second-over behind Serena Said, who had steering issues throughout, and when that filly bore out a path just past the 5/8, Miller guided his filly right through two-wide to go up and tackle the pacesetting Unspoken Promise. From there, Skater Chick had relatively clear sailing, finishing 1 3/4 lengths ahead of Alkippe, who came up the inside to catch Unspoken Promise for second, in 1:54.2. Skater Chick is trained by Mark Harder for Donald Lindsey, Paul Kleinpaste, and Garth Bechtel.

In no way did the Captaintreacherous—Musicale Hanover filly May Bride Hanover have it easy in taking her third straight Stallion Series contest. Miller took a 4-tuck early with his charge, then grinded up uncovered and was able to seize a small lead on the far turn, which she extended into the stretch. That jump was good enough to keep her clear of Michelon's Filly, who had been hampered by dull cover but came flying late to reduce the winner's advantage to a half-length at the end of the 1:53.1 mile. Nifty Norman conditions the streaking freshman, who had the fastest mile in Stallion Series prelim competition with a 1:52.3 win at The Meadows for the Pinske Stables and David Hoese.

Trillions Hanover, a daughter of

Somebeachsomewhere—Tulu Hanover, went straight to the lead in her Stallion Series cut, got to the half in a relatively slow:57.4 half-mile under Brett Miller's guidance, then scurried home in:55 – :27 to winning by an easy 4½ lengths in 1:52.4, fastest of all the Thursday divisions and a personal best. Trillions Hanover became a winner in a Stallion Series contest for the second straight time for trainer Tom Fanning and the ownership of Fanning Racing LLC, VIP Internet Stables LLC, and the J L Benson Stable Inc.

The Somebeachsomewhere–Foxy Lady miss What A Fox benefited from the red-hot hands of driver Andrew McCarthy to post an upset in her division, holding off 1-5 favorite Darn Tootn Hanover by a neck to take a maiden mark of 1:54.4. McCarthy sent his filly first-over down the backstretch, grinded to the lead shortly after turning for home, then held off the steady late rush of the favorite, who came from sixth at the ¾ pole, to triumph for trainer Brett Pelling and owner David McDuffee.
