The only job that Phil Collura, 64, ever had in the commonly accepted sense was as a toll taker on the New Jersey Turnpike. He started taking tolls at a salary of \$4 an hour. When he retired after 32 years in 2011, he might have been making around \$70,000 a year. Yet today his assets might be worth in the millions of dollars. How did it come about one might ask? It started through harness racing and an involvement in the mighty Burke organization. Such is the tale of Collura, not only a significant owner in the sport, but also one of its biggest fans.

Today you own parts of somewhere around 200 horses. The total worth of these horses is likely somewhere in the tens of millions of dollars. You certainly do not come from wealth. You never earned a lot on your, so to say "9-to-5" job. How did it happen?

"I was a huge fan of the sport. My dad took me to the races at Freehold Raceway which was my home track when I was just a kid. He made my first bet for me. It was a \$2 bet on the daily double. I won and collected somewhere around \$30. I was hooked. I thought to myself 'This is easy.' I soon learned differently.

To register to bid, visit preferredequineonline.com "I worked the graveyard shift on the Jersey Turnpike, so I began going to Freehold Raceway every day. I was friendly with Tom Cherichello and mentioned to him that I thought it would be fun to own part of a horse. He said that he would introduce me to Ron Burke. If Ron and I hit it off, maybe I could own part of a horse in his stable. We did and I bought a piece of a \$4,000 claimer named Use Your Imagination. He won his first race for us. I thought to myself, 'This is great. I Love It.' As luck would have it, in his next start he blew a tendon and was never to race again.

"Thus, in the stretch of just a few days I experienced both the highs and lows of horse ownership. It didn't matter that much that he was done after his second start. I had experienced the indescribable thrill of winning. From that point forward I invested every dollar I could afford into owning horses. I've sometimes wondered what might have happened if he had broken down in that first start instead of the second."

One might certainly ask, how does a guy who is a toll collector on the New Jersey Turnpike come to afford to own parts of 200 horses?

"I suppose my horse holdings just grew. I never had a whole lot of money. But whatever I had, I used to buy more horses. Thanks to Ronnie Burke, the Burke family and Mark Weaver, the horses did well and there was more money to invest.

"I was a harness racing junkie. Whatever spare time I had, I used in going to the track. I suppose you could say that I became consumed with the sport. I read anything related to it. I listened to anybody involved in it. I worked the graveyard shift on the Turnpike, so I'd go to work with Sports Eye, race programs, the Horseman and Fair World and Hoof Beats. Working that shift allowed me lots of time to read up and further my knowledge."

Is your interest in the sport today as much as it has ever been?

"Without a doubt. I live within a half hour drive from Pocono Downs. They race four days a week. I am there four days a week. The only time I ever miss a card is when I am at another track watching my horses race, or at a horse sale, or at one of the farms looking at yearlings with other members of the Burke Brigade."

Would you say your involvement with the Burke Stable is part of a group effort?

"Yes. There are two types of owners involved with the stable. I would describe them as being passive owners and active owners. They are all led by Ronnie Burke who is in complete charge of the operation. Next in line would be Mark Weaver whose expertise relates mostly to buying and selling racehorses. Larry Karr and myself like to tag along and like to impart our knowledge when it comes to the purchase of yearlings. We both consider ourselves to be fairly knowledgeable on pedigrees. We also have what I believe to be a wealth of statistics available when we visit the farms and go to the sales. For example, if we are looking at a yearling who is the third foal from a mare, we have records which will tell us how much that mare's previous two foals sold for, who bought them, how they performed on video and what Ronnie thought of them. If we tried to buy any of them, how far in the bidding we went. We also rarely, if ever, go to a farm until after the videos of their yearlings have been posted and we have had a chance to study them.

"In recent years Dr. Bridgette Jablonsky, 'Dr. J' has joined our team. What a remarkable asset she is. When we go to a farm or are at the sale looking at yearlings she has been there before and she has made an assessment of the yearlings. The

We might look at a third of the number of yearlings we had previously looked at because Dr.J has been there before and eliminated a substantial portion of therm. Generally speaking, I would say that Ronnie's and Dr. J's taste in yearlings are somewhat the same. The only substantial difference might be that generally speaking Ronnie is perhaps more likely to accept a larger horse, whereas Dr.J is more inclined towards a medium sized one."

You describe yourself as still being a great fan of the sport who has never really strayed from you first love, betting on horses.

"That is certainly so. I'm not a big gambler. But I like to bet. In terms of how much I bet, I would guess that it probably averages out to between \$10 and \$20 a race. I am at Pocono Downs just about every day that they are open. The handle is low and a significant number of chalk wins, so most of my betting is on so called exotics. I particularly like the Pick-5s and Pick-4s."

You might have as many as a dozen horses racing on a given day. How do you keep track of them?

"I have a Virtual Stable with the USTA. This enables me to know which horses are in to race and where they are racing. Obviously, I can't be there to see most of them race. But I watch replays of all their races."

At this time of year, when many of your horses are in stakes races, do you get to the tracks where they are competing?

"I try to get to as many of the tracks as I am able to. But the truthful answer to that question is probably not near as often as I'd like to or as I feel I probably should. My wife and I have a dog which we consider to be part of our family. We are not about to go and leave her in a kennel or with someone who we are not certain will take what we feel is proper care of her. If I know that there is a big race coming up, I try to make my plans accordingly. Either I will go without my wife Mary Lou or we will make certain that Shade, our dog, is in the best of hands. We are planning to go to the Metro in Canada in a few weeks and we have made plans for Shade to be cared for.

"Because of some previously made plans, I unfortunately will not be able to be at this week's Wellwood Memorial where I feel we have a good shot. I'll have to be content with watching it on my computer."

How are your 200 or so horses made up?

"[I have] 150 racehorses, 22 broodmares, 16 yearlings, 14 sucklings and shares in five stallions. These numbers will likely change somewhat, especially the number of yearlings once the sales get going."

You have been invested in the career of Sweet Lou from the time he was a yearling, first as a racehorse and then and now as a stallion. Are you at all surprised at the amazing success that he has attained in the stud, to the point where he is considered by some to be the No. 1 pacing stallion in the world?

"Truthfully, without bragging, not in the slightest. I fully expected him to become a great stallion, maybe the best of them all. He possessed the rare combination of what so few stallions have. He was not only a great 2-year-old, but he also was a great horse in every year that he raced, continuing through the older ranks. He had all the attributes that I believe one should look for in a great stallion — looks, breeding, soundness, early speed, late speed and endurance. The truth is, I would have been surprised and deeply disappointed if he had not become great in the breeding ranks."

Working that shift allowed me lots of time to read up and further my knowledge.

When you go to the sales how do you determine how far you will go on a particular yearling?

"We leave it entirely up to Ronnie. We feel he has a pretty good handle on how much a horse is worth. Sometimes, but rarely, if Ronnie has stopped on a particular horse one of us might urge him to go a little further and make another bid or two, which he will probably do."

Are you in on all of the Burke purchases?

"Today, that is almost always the case. It was not always so. Two notables that I missed out on were Hannelore Hanover and Mission Brief. Hannelore Hanover because we were not particularly interested in having Indiana-breds at the time. With Mission Brief, she had been purchased by a different ownership group and given to Ronnie to train. The only other yearlings that I might not be involved with are those where homebreds are owned by somebody not in the core group and are given to Ronnie to train."

Last year you started with 56 yearlings, soon to become 2-year-olds at the Burke Training Center in Florida. How do you, or, in fact, do you keep track of their progress?

"Ronnie sends us training reports on how he believes they are doing about once a month. In addition, I go down a couple of times each winter as does Larry Karr. So do other members of the team. We communicate among each other and I feel we gain a pretty good reading on how they are progressing.

"This year we will be missing a very important cog in the makeup of the organization. We lost Mickey Burke last spring. He was the man who was in charge of the entire group of youngsters each winter as well as a few other quality horses who we felt would be helped by Mickey's great experience and superb horsemanship. Such people are never replaced."

Chantilly is undefeated following Eternal Camnation victory

Saturday (Aug. 24) night at Woodbine Mohawk Park, Chantilly remained undefeated after downing seven rivals in the first of two \$110,000 Eternal Camnation Stake divisions.

The lightly-campaigned Chantilly (p, 2, 1:50.4s; \$151,725) is Canada's fastest 2-year-old pacer so far this season. After a maiden-breaking July 9 victory in Ontario Sires Stakes Grassroots at Mohawk, the four-length winning margin suggested that Gold was more to her taste.

She stepped up to capture her first OSS Gold start July 16 for regular driver James MacDonald in 1:50.4, which stands as Canada's quickest 2024 mile by a freshman pacer.

After a short break, Chantilly was back at Mohawk on Aug. 10, winning a qualifier in preparation for her \$150,000 OSS Gold mid-season final on Aug. 16. She reeled off another off-the-pace victory that race, a 1:51.2 win from post 8, which she has also landed for her Eternal Camnation division.

Her trainer, Nick Gallucci, said Friday (Aug. 23) that Chantilly was surprisingly unremarkable during her early lessons.

"Chantilly was very normal to break," he told HRU. "Can't really say she stood out at that time. She was always very comfortable in whatever we asked her to do training. Nothing bothered her."

It might also be surprising that dam Shiraz Seelster (p, 2, 2:01h; \$28,670) only won a single race in two years on the track.

"I'd have to say Chantilly would be better compared to her father," said Gallucci. "Her mother did not have much athletic ability or desire, but Big Jim [p, 2, 1:49.1s; \$1,541,924] had everything you could ask for in a young racehorse."

The stallion was voted 2010 Dan Patch and O'Brien 2-Year-Old Pacing Colt of the Year.

Chantilly is the first and only racing foal of Shiraz Seelster, who came up barren after a 2023 mating with Shadow Play. With no siblings of racing age and no similarity to her dam's past performance, Chantilly left Gallucci at a loss for words when it came to explaining her success.

"It's hard for me to pinpoint what has put her on top in the OSS," he said. "Up until now, she has just been a special talent. I just hope we can keep her this good."



Gallucci is aware of the challenges associated with keeping pacing fillies and mares at the top of their game. He also trains 2021 O'Brien 2-Year-Old Pacing Filly of the Year Prohibition Legal (p, 4, 1:50.0s; \$816,800), who faced her currently-stronger stablemate Silver Label (p, 4, 1:47.3m; \$1,266,309) and 2023 O'Brien Somebeachsomewhere Horse of the Year Sylvia Hanover in Saturday (Aug. 24) night's WMP filly and mare preferred handicap pace (results unavailable prior to press time).

"Prohibition Legal has had some muscle soreness issues so far this year," he said. "We are hoping to finish the year stronger than she started. I'd say the competition is definitely as good as it gets in the aged mare division. Twin B Joe Fresh, Silver Label, as well as Sylvia Hanover and Tells On A Roll... You have to be on top of your game to be competitive in this division."

The Stouffville, ON trainer said both Silver Label and Prohibition Legal were both likely to "race like they have been recently" on Saturday night at Mohawk. Gallucci has trained the 5-year-old mares throughout their careers, as they are both Millar Farms homebreds, like Chantilly.

"It sure looks like Millar Farms [of Stouffville, ON] has a great focus on developing female pacers, but I think it's mostly coincidence, because we always seem to have more fillies than colts," said Gallucci. "This year, we had 10 fillies versus one colt. George [Millar] is a great owner, and he only wants what's best for his horses long term, and it has worked out well for him."

Working with homebreds allows Gallucci to gain early insights not otherwise consistently available.

"I do think having the horses come from the broodmare farm helps me as a trainer," he said. "You get to see them develop from day one, and you know their tendencies better than you would with a yearling bought from a yearling sale."

That depth of knowledge about each trainee has convinced Gallucci that Chantilly's precocious ability is not a drawback to her future racing career.

"I do think early speed in any 2-year-old does have some negative impacts on some horses," he said. "Others, maybe not as much. But I think, as a trainer, you have to manage them accordingly, to try and keep the horses sound and healthy."

Gallucci cited the current top horse (mare) in the Hambletonian Society-Breeders Crown weekly top 10 poll as an example.

"Twin B Joe Fresh [p, 4, 1:47.3m; \$1,860,165] is a perfect example of good management," Gallucci said. "She was shut down [in early October] at 2, and is still number one in the game as a 4-year-old."

The 4-year-old mare was the fastest of her generation at age 2, taking a 1:48.4 freshman speed badge on Aug. 14, 2022 at The Red Mile.

Although Chantilly's American counterpart Papi Grad has captured attention with her near-perfect record, Gallucci said the two will not face each other on the track this year.

"We did not keep Chantilly eligible for the Breeders Crown this year," he said.

Two-year-olds cannot be supplemented to the Breeders Crown.

"Who knows, maybe next year they will get to test the waters together," Gallucci said.





Driving forces

Where some top drivers stand on the all-time wins and earnings lists.

Before we see you in September, let us take a look at how some top drivers currently stand on the all-time lists for wins and earnings.

1. Yannick Gingras (#4 all-time with \$238.6 million) recently rattled off a record 10-win day at Harrah's Philadelphia – the first seven in a row – coming the same month he broke through in the Hambletonian with Karl. He's well on his way currently with \$8 million, with a week of August left, to the goal of hitting at least \$11 million again. The only reason he's not going for his 15th-straight year of \$11-million plus is the COVID year of 2020 (\$9.2 million).

2. Dave Miller is at \$286.7 million for his career as the #1 active earning driver with a week to go in August. He's the record holder with 17 \$10-million seasons and incredibly with three others at \$9.7 million plus but not quite \$10 million. With 85,420 drives both he and Gingras have never had a 3,000-drive single season. Somewhat forgotten is that Miller's six biggest seasons in victories came the six seasons prior to his move to the East Coast, 1993-98. His .327 UDRS as of mid-August 2024 – if he maintains it – would be his personal highest since his .384 of 1998. Miller's had four \$12 million seasons.

3. John Campbell, more than seven years since he last drove, he still holds a trunk full of records. When Gingras posted seven-straight it brought back memories of that rainy night in the first week of February of 1983 at The Meadowlands where, on a 10-race card, Campbell won the first seven, then had a scratch with the aptly named Rain In The Face, then was second in his last drive. They were not obvious choices either: Tiger Chris (\$10.60), R Ds Hots (\$9.40), Arbor Bachelor (\$6), Travel Agency (\$11.40), Sams Butch (\$13.40), Point After (\$5.40), and Sunny Airliner (\$5.40). The record at that time for consecutive wins was eight by Herve Filion and currently it is Stephane Bouchard at 11 on the same day.

4. Dave Palone, currently at 20,921 victories in 81,079 attempts, owns the highest winning percentage at 25.8 per cent of any of the top 25 winningest dash-drivers ever. Walter Case, Jr. is the only other over 25 per cent. Palone's first win was on March 15, 1983 at The Meadows with Reds Folly who he also trained. The

4-year-old daughter of Plucky Boy—Lisa Havens went 2:04 2 and paid \$5.20 in the claiming event for a purse of \$2,100, where she was in for a tag of \$14,500. Palone had turned 21 the month prior and in limited action in 1982 he was winless in 14 tries.

5. Peter Wrenn recently edged past John Campbell into the #15 spot all time in victories, 10th among active drivers with 10,683. Wrenn remains, unless foolproof evidence comes forth, the only driver ever to be the leading driver at nine separate tracks.

And finally: Sept. 1, 2024 is fast approaching. It marks the 48th anniversary of the opening of The Meadowlands in 1976, the 30th anniversary of the opening of Hoosier Park in 1994 and the 35th birthday of one, Dexter Dunn. Sept. 2 marks 84 years since Roosevelt Raceway introduced nighttime harness racing to the world in 1940. Roosevelt fell just a couple months shy of the 48 years The Meadowlands will soon realize closing on July 15, 1988.





Pandemic panic

Simple twists of fate from the wild world of horse breeding.

We plan. Maybe things work out, maybe not. Meanwhile, mystical randomness and inexplicable connections happen. If you don't squeeze into the crowded bus, you never meet the love of your life. A stranger you meet at table #12 at your cousin's wedding leads to a career. You turn left instead of right. The arrow ricochets off your belt buckle. Big things, little things, all are part of the tapestry of life.

The random wheel also turns in our sport. Let me share:

Once upon a time, my pal and I had a 3-year-old filly trotter in training. We purchased the yearling filly at the Ohio Select Yearling Sale. We bought her to race, not as a broodmare prospect. We already were at our broodmare maximum – one. We sent her to a well-regarded trainer.

Our filly struggled as a racehorse, and she got sore as a 2-year-old, so we turned her out. As spring rolled around in her sophomore season, our hopes dimmed. She slid from the annual dream of becoming a Sires Stakes performer to perhaps becoming a fair horse. This tale is as old as harness racing.

The world had more significant problems than our obscure borderline trotting filly racehorse in 2020. Across the land was the fear of looming death from the mutating coronavirus. These were the days of masks and handwashing and gurneys with bodies covered in white sheets rolling out of hospitals. There were days of drive-by funerals, hoarded mountains of toilet paper, and Netflix marathons. Tantrums from people livid about too many masks and restrictions, and others livid that others did not unite to follow best practices. The world was on edge.

Racetracks were closed. One of those early pandemic mornings, I pulled into a parking spot after a worker wearing rubber gloves and a surgical mask handed me my coffee and Egg McMuffin through a drive-thru window. I began to scroll on my phone for information about when and if harness horse racing would return, wondering if our filly in training would even get the opportunity to race.

On my phone screen, I saw that the HRU site had some breeding advertising. I recall that this simple advertisement was a note from a farm thanking their customers for supporting their stallions again this season. Maybe this was the stimulus, I don't know, but suddenly, a random thought popped into my head, "Would it be possible to breed our unraced filly instead of waiting for the harness racing and real worlds to get back on their feet?"

As my coffee cooled, I phoned my pal with my lunacy. He was skeptical. The filly was in training, and we barely remembered her pedigree. We decided to see if this was even a remote possibility. I called Midland Acres, the operator of the closest breeding farm to the training facility where our filly was in limbo. They picked up the phone on the first ring, humored me, and told me they had a Long Tom breeding available for sale and that we could try it.

I again called my pal. He called the trainer, who agreed to immediately ship the filly just down the road to the breeding farm. There was zero planning or research. From a weird random idea to action took less than 10 minutes. My coffee was still warm.

To our astonishment, we received the call about a week later that our filly was in foal. Eleven months later, we welcomed a new foal. Another calendar year flew past as the baby grew big and strong. We consigned her to the Ohio Select Sale. She sold to a group of Ohio guys, and our pandemic filly was off (hopefully) to the races.

This filly (now age 3) was fourth in the Moni Maker Stakes race, trotting her mile in :52:3. She has a 1:54 race mark. She is a top trotter with a bright future. That is a long way from a random spark of an idea and two phone calls in a parking lot in the middle of a pandemic.


Often, we sit back and examine the many twists of fate along our roads. In this isolated case, if there was no pandemic, two people did not pick up their phones, or a different breeding farm was down the road - many things needed to happen to result in this excellent trotter. We can all conjure up hundreds of what-if moments that remind us of the cosmos and the mysterious forces beyond our comprehension.

The story of this accidental broodmare and the fine trotter she birthed began in a parking lot during a pandemic. More twists of fate awaited this family.

Ontario SIRE STAKES REPORT

Its A Love Thing streaks to Ontario Sires Stakes victory

Three-year-old pacing filly **Its A Love Thing** earned her fifth straight victory in stakes action with a dominating performance in the fourth Gold Series leg of the Ontario Sires Stakes on Friday night (Aug. 23) at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Its A Love Thing was followed by Pass Line, giving trainer Dave Menary a sweep of the exactor in the \$140,000 event.

Driver James MacDonald made the winning move with Its A Love Thing once Lightning Lizzie (Brett MacDonald) and Odds On Platinum (Sylvain Filion) traded turns on the lead through a :56 first half. On the move from fifth midway down the backstretch, Its A Love Thing went head-to-head with the front-striding Odds On Platinum as they raced by three-quarters in 1:22.4 and swept by off the final turn with stablemate Pass Line chasing her cover and taking over second-place through the stretch for Doug McNair. Its A Love Thing was victorious in 1:50 by 1¾ lengths over Pass Line, with One More Bet (Louis-Philippe Roy) getting up in the battle for third.

"She loves to race horses and she sees that horse on front and it's hard to throttle her back when you get her out there," said MacDonald in a post-race interview. "She just wants to go so fast and run them into the ground. She's been a lot of fun to drive and hopefully it's just the tip of the iceberg with her."

Menary said, "She's just special. James always puts her in the right spot and even when she's not in the right spot, she seems to be able to overcome it. She gives me tingles."

The O'Brien Award runner-up to Pass Line as a freshman, It's a Love Thing has stepped out of her stablemate's shadow in her sophomore season, winning seven stakes with her only losses being second-place finishes in a pair of elimination events. Among her victories this year, the one-eyed filly has conquered Grand Circuit foes in the Fan Hanover and Jerry Silverman Memorial and is perfect in three Ontario Sires Stakes starts, including the mid-season Gold final last month.

"Early on, there were two starts when she was second and third – and should have won by six – from running out,"

said Menary. "We corrected that steering last year and this year it's kind of been clear sailing. She matured and kind of grew into herself and she just loves to do it."

The Ontario-sired 3-year-old pacing fillies will meet again for the final preliminary leg on Sept. 26 before the Super Final on Oct. 12. Its A Love Thing is also scheduled to compete in the Simcoe Stakes and Kentucky Sire Stakes final before her next Gold appearance.

Sent postward as the 3-5 favorite, Its A Love Thing paid \$3.40 to win and \$2.30 to place. There was no show wagering.

The millionaire daughter of Bettors Delight and Love For Sail is owned by Eric Good, Thomas Biederman, Joshua Green and Rich Lombardo Racing.

Rose sets 1:50.2 track record in Friday's PASS at The Meadows

Rose blistered the mile in 1:50.2, fastest ever by a freshman filly pacer at Hollywood Casino at The Meadows, in Friday's Pennsylvania Sires Stake known as the Meadow Cheer. **Blessed Hanover** captured the other division, giving trainer Ron Burke a Meadow Cheer sweep.

Papi Grad was out to extend her career unbeaten streak to six and sweep all four PASS preliminary legs, but Rose and Yannick Gingras had other ideas. When Papi Grad ducked from post 7 and got away seventh, Rose had the field right where she wanted it. She quarter-moved to the point for Gingras, and though Papi Grad made a valiant first-over bid, the daughter of Sweet Lou—Rosemary Rose defeated her comfortably by 4¼ lengths, with Beckoning Yankee third.

The time knocked a tick from both the track and stake records established last year by Lyons Legend.

"When Papi Grad took back, it made my job easier," Gingras said. "But I'm telling you, don't discount Rose. That's the first time I've had her on the front, and she raced really good. But she's just as good following a helmet, and she can sprint like no other. I wouldn't trade her for anyone."

Rose, who surpassed \$100,000 in earnings, races for Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi LLC, Jack Piatt III and Larry Karr.

Blessed Hanover was third inside as the field turned for home - exactly where winning driver Ronnie Wrenn, Jr. wanted to be.

"I was happy to be following the two horses I was behind," Wrenn said. "I wasn't going to move earlier, except maybe in the last turn, but there was no room. I was content sitting third and shaking loose late. If you keep her covered up until late, she has a good kick home."

Blessed Hanover poured through the Lightning Lane and won her third straight in a career-best 1:51.2, a head better than Beach Rules. Royally Hot completed the ticket. Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi LLC and Bill Donovan campaign the daughter of Always B Miki–Bettor B Lucky, who also soared over \$100,000 in earnings.



Brett Miller piloted the daughter of Betting Line – She's A Fan to her third-consecutive win for trainer Jamie Sullivan and owner Frank Chick. Allegra Hanover, the 3-5 favorite, was three-quarters-of-a-lengths back in second with Lyons Anitasangel third.

Sullivan initially tried Stevie Hanover in sires stakes but thought the stallion series would be more to her liking.

"We wanted to build her confidence up," Sullivan said. "We're doing it race by race, trying to keep her sound and see what happens. We staked her up to everything, including the Breeders Crown; it's just touch and go."

Pilar Hanover, Beyonsay Yankee and **Odds On Aces Full** took the stake's other splits, with Tim Tetrick (Pilar Hanover, Beyonsay Yankee) enjoying a double.

Sabonis surges to ninthstraight win in Indiana Sire Stakes

On a night where upsets were aplenty, **Sabonis** rewarded the bettor's faith in him and delivered at 1-9 to extend his winstreak to nine in the penultimate leg of Indiana Sire Stakes for 3-year-old pacing colts on Friday (Aug. 23) at Harrah's Hoosier Park. **Stat That** pulled a 29-1 shocker in the first division for sophomore pacing colts, while trainer Henry Graber, Jr. swept both divisions of Sire Stakes for 2-year-old trotting fillies which co-headlined the 13-race card.

Making his first start since his victory in the \$300,000 Milstein Memorial on Aug. 10, Sabonis was sent away from post 6 in the \$50,000 Sire Stakes division with regular pilot Joey Putnam in the bike. Putnam settled Sabonis into fifth off of the gate while Lovers Trouble (driven by Pete Wrenn) rocketed to the front of the field of seven through a wicked first quarter of :25.4. M-M's Bud (Jay Cross) moved to the lead from second on the backstretch before leading to the halfway point in :54.3 while Sabonis began his first-over charge from fifth. Sabonis wheeled into third on the final turn, 1½ lengths back of M-M's Bud who led to three-quarters in 1:22.4.

Sabonis surged alongside M-M's Bud at the top of the stretch, grabbing a short lead midway through the lane but M-M's Bud was not going to go away quietly. The two slugged it out for the length of the lane before Sabonis edged in front at the edge of the toteboard to win by three-quarters-of-a-length over M-M's Bud in 1:49.4.

Trained by Aaron Stutzman, Sabonis has won 12 of 13 in his 3-year-old campaign which has seen him bank \$343,250. Bred by Karl Dean Miller, the son of Tellitlikeitis—Gypsy Bellevue is owned by Pat Miller, and is yet to miss the board in his 15-start career having won 13 of his lifetime outings.


Earlier on the card, Stat That picked a good time to pick up the first win of his 3-year-old campaign, pulling a 29-1 shocker in the \$50,000 first division for pacing colts. Driver LeWayne Miller put Stat That in the pocket from post 2 while Premier Romeo (Kyle Wilfong) grabbed the lead through a first quarter of :26.4. Premier Romeo had things his way to the half in :55.1

before leading to three-quarters in 1:23. Stat That popped the pocket turning for home, rallying with a :27 last quarter to cross the wire first by 1¼ lengths over a hard-charging Dale Yeah (Marvin Luna) in a career best 1:50.1.

Trained by Susan Miller for owner Derek Lehman, the victory was the first through 12 starts on the year and second of the career for Stat That. With the win, the son of Check Six–Rockin Songbird has earned \$159,969 for his career.

Additionally on the Friday night card, 2-year-old trotting fillies took to the track with two divisions of their fourth leg of Indiana Sire Stakes which saw trainer Graber, Jr. sweep the pair.

Classical Jane teamed up with driver Trace Tetrick to break her maiden in the \$66,500 first division, upsetting at 22-1 to upend her heavily favored stablemate Better Tak'em (Jordan Ross). Better Tak'em took command early through a quarter of :28.1 while Classical Jane grabbed the pocket in the spreadout field of six. Better Tak'em led alone to the half in :57.1 prior to reaching three-quarters in 1:26.2, 4½-lengths clear of her stablemate. Better Tak'em began to tire late in the lane, allowing Classical Jane to pick up the pieces late and snag the victory by a quarter-length in 1:55.4.

Owned by Eleven Star Stable, Frank Baldachino, Beasty and Backroad Stable, the daughter of Swan For All–Class Angel has earned \$39,905 with her first win in six outings.

The \$66,000 second division held much more to form with **Miracle Maven** cruising at 1-9 in front-end fashion with driver John De Long. De Long protected the rail position off of the gate, guiding the field of five to the opening quarter in :29.3. The quintet remained in straight alignment to the half in :58.3 before Miracle Maven led to three-quarters unchallenged in 1:28.2. Sprinting home in :27.4, Miracle Maven coasted to a two-length win over Swan Jewel (Trace Tetrick) to stop the clock in 1:56.1.

The daughter of Don't Let Em—Bad Babysitter is yet to miss the board in six career outings, winning four of them for owners Eleven Star Stables, Frank Baldachino, Beasty, and Hillside Stables while banking \$100,395.

SOPHOMORE TROTTING COLTS SLUG IT OUT

Three-year-old trotting colts and geldings were in the spotlight on Thursday (Aug. 22) at Harrah's Hoosier Park, with two \$50,000 divisions of Indiana Sire Stakes on the 13-race card. **CS Flying Co-Pilot** capitalized on a perfect pocket trip to soar to victory in the first split, while **Dashing Danny** dominated with his fourthstraight win on the season in the second.

The first division served as the eighth race on the card where CS Flying Co-Pilot was sent off at 5-1 with leading driver Trace Tetrick in the bike from the far outside post 7. CS Flying Co-Pilot found himself parked to the outside of Musclefantastic (driven

by Robert Taylor) as the two dueled for the lead to the first quarter in :27.3. CS Flying Co-Pilot cleared to the lead only briefly before Knowyoucando (Kyle Wilfong) took command from third and led to the half in :56.3. Knowyoucando was a loose leader on the final turn, motoring to three-quarters 2½ lengths clear of CS Flying Co-Pilot in 1:25.4.

CS Flying Co-Pilot erased the deficit at the top of the lane before Tetrick tipped to the outside and grabbed a short lead midway through the lane. CS Flying Co-Pilot put away Knowyoucando, but now faced a two-pronged attack from Musclefantastic up the passing lane and Flirtnwiththepilot (Pete Wrenn) to his outside. Digging in late in the lane, CS Flying Co-Pilot trotted home in :28 to cross the wire a half-length clear in a career best 1:54.1. Musclefantastic finished second, Flirtnwiththepilot was third.

Doug Rideout trains the four-time winner in 12 seasonal outings for owners Flying Eagle Stable and Darin Miller. The gelded son of Pilot Discretion—DC Jewel was bred by John Stoll and has banked \$82,410 on the season and \$145,459 for his career.

Dashing Danny immediately followed and delivered convincingly at 1-9 with regular pilot Kyle Wilfong aboard to take the second division. Leaving from post 6, Dashing Danny found himself in the middle of a three-across battle for the lead entering the first turn before landing in the pocket while Ira Who (Jared Finn) crossed over to reach the quarter first in :27.2. Dashing Danny was shuffled to third on the backstretch when Elhelpski (Pete Wrenn) was given his marching orders from third and took command on the way to the halfway point in :57. Wilfong tugged the right line and Dashing Danny quickly accelerated alongside the leader as Elhelpski reached three-quarters with a narrow lead in 1:27.

The bettor's choice blew right by to the lead turning for home, trotting clear by 3½ at the eighth pole. Crossing the wire a geared down winner, Dashing Danny stopped the clock in 1:54.3, winning by three lengths over longshots A Blue Million (Mike Peterson) and First Option (Joey Putnam) who finished second and third, respectively.

Ontario Drawn Impression glides in Casual Breeze

Drawn Impression plowed from mid-pack and lifted away from her peers to score in the aptly named \$140,000 Casual Breeze at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Friday night (Aug. 23).

Stablemate Emoji Hanover hustled out of post 10 to grab the lead from R Liza by a :27.3 first quarter while driver Louis-Philippe Roy settled Drawn Impression out of post 1 into sixth. As Emoji Hanover slowed the tempo to a :57 half, Roy sent Drawn Impression uncovered out of sixth and then seized the lead entering the final turn. She strode by three-quarters in 1:25.2 and widened her lead down the stretch under a reclined hand drive to float over the finish winning by 6¼ lengths. Emoji Hanover held off R Liza zipping up the inside to take second while R Liza's rally helped her stave off Cool Ma Belle as she wove through traffic, but settled for fourth.

"I didn't find any good cover to follow once we all settled into the first turn, so I rushed my move," Roy said after the race. "But the filly's just so good. Luc's team had her really good, so I felt like she could overcome anything. It wasn't the ideal trip, but she was so good she could deal with it anyway. When you sit behind her, she goes so fast and you don't even realize; she has a very effortless gait. So that makes me think she might be very special, even more than she shows now."

Luc Blais trains Drawn Impression, a Muscle Hill filly out of a Casual Breeze champion in Emoticon Hanover, for owner/breeder Determination. She won her first race of the season from her fifth start and notched her fifth victory from 11 starts in her career, good for \$429,844.

"She's always been impressive," Roy said. "She started a little later than every other filly, which was the plan with Luc because most of her stakes are later in the



season and he wants to keep her sharp. In the short time she's been racing, I felt like she didn't have much luck. Tonight, she was able to show her talent."

Sent off as the even-money favorite, Drawn Impression returned \$4.30 to win.

PERICULUM, LOGAN PARK VICTORIOUS IN MLT ELIMS

Periculum soared over his competition while **Logan Park** moved up a placing via disqualification to win in their respective \$50,000 eliminations for the Maple Leaf Trot on Friday night (Aug. 23) at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

In the first elimination, Periculum vaulted from third over and stuck the landing to a wrapped-up open-length win in 1:51.2.

Odds-on favorite Southwind Tyrion took command from Fashion Frenzie past a :27.2 first quarter while driver Scott Zeron positioned Periculum into sixth, nestled behind It's Academic. Hillexotic meanwhile failed to find a seat at the pylons, forcing him to press forward against Southwind Tyrion and fan the flames into a :55 half.

Hillexotic maintained steady pressure on Southwind Tyrion through the final turn as It's Academic tipped from the pylons to catch the cover with Periculum in tow. Southwind Tyrion began to struggle in the fight passing three-quarters in 1:23 as Zeron sent Periculum to the center of the track. With open racetrack ahead, Periculum motored to the lead and zipped away to win by 4¾ lengths. Osceola followed the winner's move to take second while Fashion Frenzie shook free from a locked pocket for third. Hillexotic held fourth and Gaines Hanover earned the last spot into the final.

"He was everything Mattias [Melander] told me, and Mattias has done a good job driving him," Scott Zeron said after the race." [Periculum]'s got great manners out on the racetrack, and when you ask him down the lane he really fires. For the trip to work out that great, that was good luck too."

Periculum has now won five times from nine starts this season in his first year back in North America following a Scandinavian campaign last year. Marcus Melander trains the 5-year-old son of Muscle Hill who now has 10 victories from 42 tries and \$563,543 earned for owners Brixton Medical Inc. and Holly Lane Stud East Ltd.

"He's been racing great all season and he had some bad luck in those big races," Melander said. "One time he got parked, and last time he was in at Pocono against Jiggy Jog and those and he raced really good against them first over. He's better on the bigger track, especially when he can sit like this third-over or fourth over. He's really fast. He's so much stronger now than when he was 3. He carries himself a lot better... he's a very good horse."

Sent off as the 3-1 second choice, Periculum paid \$8.30 to win.

Melander appeared poised for a sweep of the Maple Leaf Trot eliminations until the steadfast Venerate bobbled in stride and

hit the finish line on an extended break, which placed runner-up Logan Park first in the second elimination.

Venerate, the 2-1 second choice, muscled out of post 6 to the point before a :27 first quarter and scurried over the track under a snug, but headstrong, hold. He clocked a :55.2 half and three-quarters in 1:22.4 before slipping from his smooth gait into a gallop as he drifted off the pylons entering the final eighth. Logan Park, sitting the pocket trip, gave pursuit up the inside and crossed the line second, one length behind Venerate, whose violation of the breaking rule forced his disqualification to 10th. M-M's Dream pushed first over to finish second after the disqualification with the remaining berths for the final going to Ghostly Casper in third, Oh Well in fourth and Helpfirstedition in fifth.

"I was trying to go up the rail a little bit," Doug McNair said after the race. "I had a bit of horse just before [Venerate] went off-stride, but other than that I just wanted to stay out of his way. He's been a great ride for the last couple of years. He won the Breeders Crown elim last year and was fourth in the final, so he shows he can go with the top horses in North America and hopefully he gets a good race next week."

Logan Park, a 6-year-old gelding by Archangel, has now won 31 races from 74 starts and banked \$1,292,644 for owners Outofthepark Stable, Reg Higgs and Arpad Szabo. Kyle Fellows trains the gelding who paid \$5.40 to win.

In winning their eliminations, Periculum and Logan Park earned a protected draw between posts 2 through 6 for the Maple Leaf Trot final, which goes to post next Saturday (Aug. 31) at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

NO ELIMS NEEDED FOR CANADIAN PACING DERBY

This year's Canadian Pacing Derby at Woodbine Mohawk Park will not require eliminations after 11 older pacers were entered on Tuesday (Aug. 20).

Royal Mission led the field to the :27.1 quarter, but favored Champagne Problems took over just before the :55.3 half and led the field through the 1:23.3 threequarter pole. Meanwhile, Monalishi was biding her time near the back of the pack and slowly worked her way up to fourth by the head of the lane. She came home in :27.4 to seal the win.

Lasting Dream was a half-length back in second. R Dutchess was third and even-money favorite Champagne Problems was fourth.

Previously driven by Jody Jamieson, MacDonald picked up the drive on Monalishi when Jamieson opted to steer R Dutchess.

"I didn't know anything about her," MacDonald told John Rallis in the winner's circle. "I talked to Jody, and Jody was more than forthcoming with information about her. But, leaving the gate, everyone was barreling out of there, and I had to kind of call an audible, and it takes a good horse to give you another big, big kick after that.

"She just kind of rode lightly on the lines the whole way, and then turning for home she was on the bit, but not raging. And I said, 'Oh, maybe we'll get a chunk.'And then every time I asked her, she just gave me a little more and a little more. Halfway down the lane, she really kicked into gear and I was pretty confident she was going to get there."

Monalishi, a daughter of Green Manalishi S out of Pretty Phylly G is trained and co-owned by Blake MacIntosh, who shares her papers with Tim Klemencic.

"I thought she'd be a lot better just chasing and finishing off the mile and it worked out that way," MacIntosh said. "It worked out perfect. James gave her a great drive, and Jody has done a hell of a job all year. I was a little upset when he picked off. But you know, what are you going to do? You gotta go with the best."

Monalishi is now 4-1-0 in six career starts and sports earnings of \$518,825.

She was bred by Shmuel Farhi of London, ON and sold for \$28,000 at the 2023 Standardbred Horse Sales Company auction in Harrisburg, PA.

Johnny Calabrese finishes sixth in amateur World Cup

Reigning USHWA amateur driver of the year Johnny Calabrese finished sixth in the recent amateur driver World Cup in Finland.

Heading into the final day of racing, Calabrese, the U.S. representative, was in third place, but he ended up just four points from fifth spot.

Calabrese's chances looked good on the first day of competition. He was on top heading for home when his horse made a break. Later by virtue of a win (shown, left to right: Fred Handelaar, Joe Frasure, race secretary at Yonkers and Calabrese) and a second in the competition, Calabrese was in strong position to finish third but was ultimately bumped from one of the three platform spots on the last day.

The competition was won by a driver from Norway, followed by Malta in second and New Zealand in third.

To date, the best U.S. performance in the amateur World Cup event remains Hannah Miller who was knocked off the top platform spot by one point in the last leg of the competition in Budapest.

Karl, Sippinonsearoc kick off the week in style at The Red Mile

Today (Aug. 25) Karl, the sport's second ranked horse and Sippinonsearoc, the fastest freshman in history, promise to commence another action-packed week of racing in the Kentucky Sire Stakes Championship Series (KYSS) for their respective ages, gaits and genders under the lights at The Red Mile.

Sippinonsearoc (Yannick Gingras) places his hooves first upon the red clay in the evening's first race. The son of Downbytheseaside—Queen Anne M and rising star seeks to improve his unblemished record to five-for-five in the third \$80,000 leg of the KYSS for freshman male pacers.

Conditioned by Ron Burke, the colt enters this event off his 1:48.2 world record clocking on Aug. 13. He will leave from post position 3 in the field of seven and is the 6-5 morning-line favorite.

Sippinonsearoc is owned by Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi, R A S Racing and Knox Services. The colt was bred by Trent Stohler Stable and Alesha Binkley. He has earned \$110,000.

His chief rival appears to be stablemate Louprint (Ronnie Wrenn, Jr.). The son of Sweet Lou-Rockin Racer has only been defeated once in four contests. That was by a neck to Sippinonsearoc as the favorite in the first leg of this series on Aug. 4.

Louprint will begin to pace from post position 5 and is 3-1 on the morning line.

The colt competes as a homebred for his trainer's racing operation, Weaver Bruscemi and Phillip Collura.

While Sippinonsearoc has shone brightly, superstar Karl will seize the spotlight when he and Gingras begin their KYSS event from post position 3 in the sixth race which is the \$80,000 third round leg for 3-year-old male trotters.

The son of Tactical Landing—Avalicious is a Dan Patch Award winner, a Breeders Crown victor and triumphed in the 99th edition of the Hambletonian on Aug. 4. A frontrunner for Horse of the Year honors is the 7-5 morning-line favorite in the field of seven for trainer Nancy Takter, who is the first person since her Hall of Fame father, Jimmy, to win consecutive Hambletonians. She is also the first female to do so.

Karl will face familiar foes Secret Agent Man (Andy Miller) who leaves right beside him in post position 4 and is 4-1 on the morning line. Dame Good Time (Scott Zeron) drew the rail and is 9-2 on the morning line.

Karl, however, has demonstrated his ability over his division on multiple occasions and set his previous lifetime mark over this surface. If the conditions are right, will he trot another historic mile?

Bred by Crawford Farms, the colt is co-owned by his breeder, his trainer and her mother Christina, Black Horse Racing and Bender Sweden.

Karl has annexed \$1.83 million from a resume of 18 16-1-1.

On Monday (Aug. 26) 2-year-old trotting fillies square off in the sole division of the \$80,000 third round of the KYSS. The previously undefeated Yo Tillie (Verlin Yoder) looks to avenge her neck loss to Aperfect Annie (Todd McCarthy) in the second round of this series.

Yo Tillie is a daughter of Tactical Landing—Consolidator and will leave from post position 7 in the field of 10 in the fifth race.

Aperfect Annie is 7-2 on the morning line and will begin trotting from post position 3. The Carter Pinske pupil is a daughter of Googoo Gaagaa—Asixpacfromperfect.

Empire Breeders Classic pacers at Tioga

The Empire Breeders Classic (EBC) will showcase the best New York-bred sophomore pacers this afternoon (Aug. 25) at Tioga Downs. Both the filly and colt stakes split into divisions with each of the four stakes racing for just into six figures. Legendary Hanover, the fastest pacing colt of 2024 by virtue of his electrifying 1:46.2 Cane Pace win, a Meadowlands track record, that came hot on the heels of his stakes record 1:46.3 Meadowlands Pace win, takes on state-bred company for the first time this year in his \$105,750 EBC division (race 10).

His season has consisted of facing the Grand Circuit types from Ontario through New Jersey and acquitting himself as the best in the division to this point for owners Erik Good, West Winds Stable and Mark Dumain. Tony Beaton trains the Huntsville colt and Canada's top driver James MacDonald is along for the ride.

"Legendary" is not in by himself however, as both Boston Rocks and Huntingforchrome have been in the trenches of the New York Sires Stakes (NYSS) sharpening their game in anticipation of the big money coming over the next few weeks.

Howlenthehills (Matt Kakaley) is a mere half-length from perfection in his 11 2024 tries, falling just that short in the Messenger Pace final. After a winless campaign at 2, the son of American Ideal is unbeaten against state-bred competition while amassing \$338,600 this year for owner Symmetry Stables and trainer Travis Alexander. Howlenthehills catches the weaker of the splits (race 8) with Escape To America the main obstacle between him and the lion's share of the \$104,500 prize.

The EBC fillies go for \$108,000 in each division, and Chris Ryder is sitting on a big hand in both as he has been all summer with his potent pair of Peace Talks (race 3) and Tarrific (race 6). Top NYSS reinsman Jason Bartlett is scheduled to drive both.

Peace Talks has collected over \$162,000 for owners Henderson Farms, Jeff Bell, FAC Racing and Bob Mondillo on the strength of two wins in nine starts this year. The American Ideal filly is also the NYSS defending champion for this division.

Tarrific has the championship gene, by New York's top sire Huntsville from Road Bet who has produced the winners of \$3.5 million with three (including Tarrific) sub 1:50 performers including world champ Cattlewash and the iron tough Niki Hill (also campaigned by Ryder). Winless at age 2, Tarrific has lived up to her blue blood at 3, winning half of her eight seasonal starts while earning \$156,515 and must be considered at the very top of the class. Margaret Dey and Let It Ride Stables share ownership.

NYSS for freshman pacing colts heads up the under card of 16 races with one NYSS division going as a 12:45 p.m. non betting affair.

And, just when it looked as though things just couldn't get any better, it's **Corntastic** weekend, too.

First post at Tioga today is 1 p.m.
