What harness racing can learn from the PGA vs. LIV Golf battle

Similarities abound in a changing racing and golf landscape.

It's been fascinating throughout this year to watch the emerging battle lines play out in the world of professional golf between the PGA Tour and a new league to rival that tour, LIV Golf. Throughout there have been unmistakable parallels to harness racing.

What makes LIV Golf different from any other golf tour is that it's funded through non-traditional means. Whereas the PGA and other traditional major tours generate revenue from media rights deals and sponsorships, LIV Golf is funded through a Saudi Arabian investment fund where to this point, the amount of compensation and tournament purses it can offer is both unrivaled and has no correlation to standard revenue generating means.

That dynamic should sound familiar to those in harness racing. Not only from the standpoint of substantial purses offered almost exclusively due to subsidies rather than handle, but the threat that LIV Golf could debatably pose to the PGA Tour rivals that of the Meadowlands in the track's ongoing battle against more heavily subsidized competition.

Both institutions integral to their industry – the PGA Tour and the Meadowlands – recognize the impact of their product as

talent is lured away by competition not beholden to the same economic model. And in formulating a stance like an approach Meadowlands CEO Jeff Gural has led with, the PGA Tour has taken sanctions resulting in bans and expulsions for any of its golfers that play in a LIV Golf tournament.

This week the Meadowlands issued a reminder for the continuing of a weekly driver approval process for the upcoming fall meet.



Harness Racing Update

In the process that was initiated towards the start of the year, the idea is that to help the Meadowlands produce the best product possible. Outside of personal downtime in the winter and competing major stakes, the top drivers have been expected to generally race at the Meadowlands over other tracks (such as most notably, Yonkers).

Communicating with Gural through email earlier this week, he reiterated his main reasons behind the approval process. Gural stated that while he feels drivers are entitled to some time off during the winter, he also believes that it's not asking a lot to drive at the Meadowlands over his competitors, especially with the Meadowlands racing only two days a week.

There's no doubt Gural believes that having the best driver present boosts his product, the same way that as more golfers defect to LIV Golf, there will come a point where top quality has been diluted.

Interestingly for the Meadowlands, it's difficult though to say if driving quality has any effect on handle. For example, the amateur driving races which have become a staple on the track's race cards handle just as well as the races with professional drivers. On the other hand, having the top drivers who are competitive is important to owners and trainers, and overall is obviously preferable in putting together what a high-quality race program should look like.

Gural noted that his acquired ability to have approval rights isn't solely to mandate that the top drivers show up, but also to ensure races are being run competitively. As Gural has emphasized on multiple prior occasions, he expects drivers to keep holes closed where possible, and to move forward when they pull, no half-in games. Gural also commented that to help with race flow and creating more movement, he is even thinking about allowing betting and a portion of the purse based on who is in front at the half-mile.

The ongoing question then remains: should drivers (or golfers for that matter), ultimately be able to act independently in their own best interests without fear of retribution or exclusion? If someone wants to race against or play against alternate competition with less tradition but for higher compensation, should there be some measure of loyalty against what's in the best interest of sport? That's a question in both industries.

Where harness racing and golf deviate is in their respective trajectories. Golf is more popular than ever and certainly due, in part, to legalized sports betting. Golf on the PGA Tour has become one of the more popular sports to wager on, and the display of live odds displayed throughout golf broadcasts is an example of the sport embracing something which was once thought of as taboo. Betting on that sport is ushering in an entirely new demographic. All of which is ironic of course, as it shows the potential for harness racing as a gambling sport at its core.

For its part, the angle coming from new rival LIV Golf is that it's going to be innovative. It's ready to evolve as golf evolves. The same can't be said, unfortunately, for harness racing. Billions of dollars in subsidies have supported the sport for over 15 years now, and how much of that has gone towards innovation?

At times over the years, Gural has led efforts to allocate small percentages from subsidies towards marketing initiatives. Almost always, these attempts were met with resistance. And as Gural noted to me this week, all it takes to end everything is a new governor averse to the public funding of racing or efforts to decouple gaming from racing as was the case in Florida.

Whatever happens in golf between the PGA Tour and its superior-funded new rival, along with all participants, is unlikely to set any precedent that would drive harness racing policy, but the parallels are still close enough that it's worth paying attention to. It's a growing sport and there's much that can be learned from it.

First call

Mixed results from calling my first race as part of the race announcer's workshop at The Meadowlands.

They say you always remember your first time.

Despite the fact that I have been married to a race caller for nearly 33 years, I've never had any desire to try it. So, what changed this year? I thought it would make for a good column.

Back in April, when I asked to be included in The Meadowlands-sponsored race announcer's workshop on July 9, I didn't realize it would start at 8 a.m.

Since my husband, Dave, didn't get home from work until 1:30 that morning, I didn't want to wake him to drive me to the workshop. Instead, I used a rideshare and, perhaps, I should have taken it as a bad sign when my driver had trouble staying in a lane, and when I finally arrived, all the doors at the front entrance to the track were locked.

The workshop is run by the "Voice of The Meadowlands", Ken Warkentin, and organized by Matt Zuccarello.

Warkentin spent the hour prior to the 9 a.m. qualifiers' post time explaining how the workshop was established and giving tips on how to call races.

The class of 10 had a few late scratches, so only seven actually participated, with three – including me – looking to break their maiden.

As they were getting ready to come onto the track for the first qualifier, Warkentin asked: "So, who wants to go first?"

I'm sure it didn't actually happen, but I think everyone suddenly took a step back.

So, I volunteered, figuring it would be good to get it over with.

When I drove in my first exhibition race, Walter Case, Jr. told me: "That feeling like you're going to throw up goes away when you step onto the track."

I was hoping the same would apply to announcing because vomit would definitely not enhance a race call.

It all became real when Warkentin put the headset on me.



Strangely enough, the nerves went away when I spotted Tim Tetrick's familiar green and yellow training suit.

The field of four filly and mare pacers was scratched down to three, which was a blessing and a curse. Obviously, I shouldn't have a problem keeping track of which horse was which, but so few competitors meant there would definitely be some dead airtime.

Not surprising for a qualifier, there was very little action until mid-stretch when Tetrick popped Treacherous Dragon out of the pocket to score in 1:52 by three-quarters-of-a-length over Queen Of Success. Hot Mess Express finished third.

At the time, I was just focused on getting through the call but it is certainly not lost on me that I got to call a race with horses of sky-high caliber.

I definitely felt great relief when it was over, and was met by kind words from the rest of the workshop, but I know I could have been better. Except for watching several baby races my

"The only way you're going to get better is reps," said Warkentin. "You need to just keep doing it."

Since there were 10 races and only seven participants, anyone who wanted to call another race had their name drawn from a hat.

Andrew Ibendahl, a marketing sciences manager and first-time caller, was lucky enough to get to call two.

"It was nerve-racking but a lot of fun at the same time," said Ibendahl after his first call. "It goes by slower and quicker than you think it would. When you talk too fast you could run out of things to say easily, so a lot of it is pacing and realizing that less is more."

I was not lucky enough to be chosen to call another race, but if I opt to do this again next year, I would like to call a bigger field. And in a perfect world, I would also like to know which race I would be calling so I could make notes, but that's not how this workshop functions.

From year to year, they never know how many qualifiers/baby races will be contested or how many people will attend the class.

If the class size outnumbers the race count, there is then a blind draw to see who gets to call.

Dan Kondel and his son, Daniel, attended the workshop for the second straight year, and even though they both got to call this year, last year only Daniel was lucky enough to have his name drawn. Donna Kondel was not a workshop participant, but was there nonetheless to support her husband and son. The Kondels are harness racing fans that can often be seen at The Meadowlands.

Following the workshop, the Kondels ran into my husband at The Big M and talked about what a great experience race calling was. Hearing Daniel's enthusiasm, Dave invited him to call a race next year at Goshen Historic Track, where Dave is the Grand Circuit announcer. The Kondels are now considering skipping their yearly beach vacation to go to Goshen instead.

Freehold Raceway announcer Edison Hatter, who normally calls Meadowlands' baby races, was on hand at the workshop and offered me the opportunity to call a race at Freehold. His idea is to get my husband and I to both call a race on the same card. Considering Freehold probably doesn't have too many three-horse fields, I'm not sure if I'm ready for that quite yet, but you never know.

I would personally like to thank The Meadowlands, Zuccarello, and most of all, Warkentin. After the workshop we all got to go home and relax for the rest of the day. Warkentin had to make a quick turnaround to be back and prepared for the eliminations for the Meadowlands Pace.

The \$25 workshop participation fee goes to the Harness Horse Youth Foundation, a charity that means a lot to Warkentin. He sees this workshop as a way to give back, something that his buddy, the late Sam McKee, would be proud of.

Charlottenlund in Copenhagen, Denmark, plays host to one of the big events of the year in Danish harness racing this

weekend. Sunday's (Aug. 28) \$162,000 Derby for 4-year-olds is the highlight of the meeting.

Jeppe Juel-trained Garfield (S.J.'s Caviar) won eight-out-of-eight races as a 3-year-old and he has three wins in four starts this season, which ought to mean that he's the probable favorite when the 12 horses strong field will gather behind the car on Sunday afternoon.

The Danish Derby is a 3,000 meters race and it's usually a well-attended event in Copenhagen.

Miller hopes French Wine pours it on in William Wellwood Memorial

A vintage French Wine performance Saturday night at Woodbine Mohawk Park could turn into a champagne celebration for conditioner Julie Miller in less than a month's time.

Two years ago, Miller sent out Venerate to take the inaugural Mohawk Million. This weekend, the multiple stakes winning trainer could get another shot at capturing the high profile, unique event for 2-year-old trotters.

The William Wellwood Memorial winner will not only take home the lion's share of the \$665,000 purse but also receive a slot, for free, in the prestigious \$1 million (USD) Mohawk Million.

For Miller, the first order of business is punching the ticket to the big race by winning another important one.

Harness Racing Update

French Wine, a son of Bar Hopping—Creamy Mimi, will take on nine rivals in the William Wellwood. He's co-owned by her husband, driver Andy Miller, Daniel and Jean-Christopher Plouffe, and One Legend Stable Inc.

"We liked Bar Hoppings because we've had success with them. Andy actually drove Creamy Mimi to her Hambletonian Oaks win, so there's a nice connection there too. We went and saw the horse at Kentuckiana and he was gorgeous. He had a really nice look about him. We liked him a lot. Luckily, so did the other owners, and a partnership was born that night."

Sporting a record of 3-1-1 from five starts, accompanied by \$126,508 in purse earnings, the colt, to be driven by Andy Miller, arrives at Saturday evening's race off a third in a Wellwood elimination on Aug. 20.

Sent off as the even-money choice, French Wine, departing from post seven, rallied strongly down the lane to secure the show spot in the 1:55.2 race won by Oh Look Magic.

"It was new surroundings and a new surface for the horse. I thought it was a really nice effort. It seems like once a horse has a start over a new surface, they find their footing a little better the next time."

Bred by Marvin Katz and Al Libfeld, French Wine made his debut on July 15 at The Meadowlands, finishing second, a neck back of winner and Wellwood final foe International Man. The \$120,000 purchase at the 2021 Lexington Select Sale then launched a three-race win streak, the last two victories coming at Red Mile.

Miller is hopeful her rising star rookie, leaving from post one, can produce a veteran-like performance on Saturday night.

"Venerate won the Million out of the 10-hole, so I'm not postprejudice anymore," she said with a laugh. "French Wine is a good-feeling horse, very social, and nice to be around. On the track, he tries every time, and he has a lot of heart. He's a real pleasure."

Miller isn't just a big fan of French Wine, the horse.

"I like French wines, U.S. wines, and Spanish wines too. Hopefully, we have something to toast to after Saturday night and next week. We just have a lot of gratitude to be in this race with a chance to be in the Mohawk Million. Hopefully, we can get there."

The other nine slots in the Mohawk Million were sold earlier this year for \$100,000 (CAD) each.

The nine slot owners are not required to declare a 2-year-old trotter for the race until entry time on Sept. 19. Each slot is an entity that may be sold, traded or subject to lease.

Four of the owners will be represented in the Wellwood Memorial. Glengate Farms are co-owners of Oh Look Magic, and Southwind Coors. Determination owns Tuscan Prince, Brad Grant co-owns Snowpiercer, and Gino Toscani owns Dahlquist Hanover.

The original announcement of the Mohawk Million and slot-deciding Wellwood Memorial was made on Sept. 26, 2019, one year to the date before the inaugural Mohawk Million was contested.

The Mohawk Million on Sept. 24 is the feature event on one of harness racing's richest cards of the year. More than \$3.3 million in purses will be up for grabs on the 'Million' card with the \$825,000 Metro Pace, \$600,000 Canadian Trotting Classic, \$500,000 Shes A Great Lady and \$400,000 Elegantimage also in the spotlight.

The William Wellwood Memorial is carded as Race 10 (10:45 p.m.) on Saturday's \$1.7 million stakes-filled card at Woodbine Mohawk Park. Post time for the 12-race card is 7 p.m.

Cecere duo aim for **Wellwood glory**

There is little mystery surrounding International Man, which makes working with the colt a pleasure for trainer Domenico Cecere.

International Man has won two of three races this year, including an elimination of the William Wellwood Memorial for 2-yearold trotters last weekend at Woodbine Mohawk Park. The Lindy Farms-owned homebred, from the first crop of stallion International Moni, will start Saturday's (Aug. 27) C\$665,000 Wellwood final from post six with Yannick Gingras in the sulky.

His sire, International Moni, was bred and raced by the Moni Maker Stable, which includes members of Lindy Farms' Antonacci family as well as David Reid. International Moni was a multiple winner on the Grand Circuit, including the Goodtimes Stakes at Mohawk in 2017.

"He reminds me a lot of his father because he's so laid back with a nice gait," Cecere said. "I really like him. It's enjoyable to train a horse like him. International Moni was a pleasure to train, too. We love International Moni, and it looks like we have a nice son of his. It's very nice to see them go the right way."

> International Man, out of the mare Birthright, is a halfbrother to filly Raised By Lindy, who last year at age 2 won three times on the Grand Circuit and lost by a nose to Joviality S in the Breeders Crown. "He's got a lot of pedigree," Cecere said. "I'm very

International Man won his debut in 1:55 in a division of the Kindergarten Classic Series at The Meadowlands, then was beaten by a neck in a third-place finish in the second leg of the event. He won his Wellwood elim by a half-length over Southwind Coors in 1:56.

"He won the first start from off a helmet, and then in his next start he got stuck on front, but I liked that he fought until the end," Cecere said. "He's still a little bit green, but he's improving. We made some changes with his bridle at Mohawk after talking with Yannick and he responded. He had a nice race. I know they went slow (1:00.1) the first half, but I'll take it. I think we're in good shape."

In addition to International Man, Cecere will send out Winner's Bet in the Wellwood final. The colt also won an elimination, besting Tuscan Prince by a neck in 1:56.3. The son of Walner-Side Bet Hanover was purchased for \$200,000 at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale and is owned by Lindy Farms and Robert Rudolph.

Winner's Bet debuted with a third-place finish in a leg of the New Jersey Sire Stakes, then got a three-week respite before finishing second in the New Jersey Sire Stakes Consolation. Two weeks later, he won a second-round division of the Kindergarten in 1:55.

Dexter Dunn will drive Winner's Bet in the Wellwood final, leaving from post four.

"In the beginning, he could get a little bit hot, a little bit anxious," Cecere said. "We took our time with him and went easy. He's a very powerful horse. He always showed he had a lot of speed and class, but he wanted to do so much so quick. I'm very proud of him. He's really come around."

The third of the three Wellwood eliminations was won by Oh Look Magic in 1:55.1, the fastest time of the season for a 2-yearold trotter in Canada. Oh Look Magic, the winner of three of five races this year, will have James McDonald at the lines for trainer John Bax and starts from post five.

Saturday's card at Mohawk also includes the Peaceful Way Stakes final for 2-year-old female trotters, two divisions of the Nassagaweya Stakes for 2-year-old male pacers, two divisions of the Eternal Camnation for 2-year-old female pacers, and eliminations of the Canadian Pacing Derby for older male pacers. The William Wellwood Memorial is race 10 on the 12-race card, which begins at 7 p.m. (EDT). The winner of the Wellwood receives the final starting spot in the Mohawk Million, which is Sept. 24.

"It's exciting," Cecere said. "Both of our horses looked nice. It looks like the plans we made for them are going the right way. Hopefully, it continues that way.

"Now, we'll try to finish the job."

Crown and **The Gruffalo** were sent off as heavy favorites in the two \$78,700 New York Sire Stakes events for 2-year-old colt and gelding trotters on Tuesday night (Aug. 23) at Yonkers Raceway, and both of them would go home with victories.

Driven by Brian Sears in the first division, Crown got away in third from post one but was brought to the outside racing to the :29.1 opening quarter and cleared The Strawboss (Jason Bartlett) for the lead after that marker. From that point, Crown cruised through fractions of :58.4 and 1:28.3 and then used a 29-second last quarter to draw off and win by 4 1/4 lengths in 1:57.3. Crown's entrymate Onion Gum (Jordan Stratton) finished second after a first-over trip out of fourth in the last quarter, and Seven Over (Tyler Buter) rallied from sixth to third.

A Chapter Seven—Amour Heiress colt, Crown was bred by Order By Stable and is trained by Marcus Melander for owner S R F Stable. Crown, who sold for \$250,000 at last year's Lexington Selected Yearling Sale, has won all four of his starts, and he has now earned \$104,075. He paid \$2.20 to win as part of a 1-9 entry and keyed a \$70.00 exacta and a \$215.50 trifecta.

In the other split, Wild Bill Kelso (Stratton) stepped to the front from post five, but Buter had The Gruffalo out and on the move from third as they raced in the backstretch for the first time, and The Gruffalo overtook Wild Bill Kelso beyond the :29.2 opening quarter. After he had command, The Gruffalo backed down the tempo to :59.1 at the half and 1:29.1 at three-quarters, and a :29.2 kicker got him to the wire three-quarters of a length ahead of Wild Bill Kelso in a 1:58.3 effort. Cecil Hanover (Ake Svanstedt) finished third after stalling out from first-over going to three-quarters.

Trainer Mark Harder also co-owns The Gruffalo, a Chapter Seven—Clementine Dream colt who was bred by Concord Stud Farm and bought for \$75,000 at the 2021 Standardbred Horse Sale, with partners Racing Team Of America, Deena Frost, and Emma Pettersson. The Gruffalo has compiled a record of 3-1-0 from five appearances, pushed his bankroll to \$93,075, and returned \$2.90 to win as the 2-5 favorite. The exacta was worth \$10.80 and the trifecta kicked back \$72.50.

Sears swept the pair of \$15,000 New York Excelsior "A" Series tests for rookie trotting males on the card with **Kaleun** [2:00] and **Maximum Express** [2:01.1]. Kaleun, by Chapter Seven and bred by Winbak Farm, is also trained by Melander for owner Courant Inc., and Maximum Express, by Credit Winner and bred by Dunroven Stud, is co-owned by trainer Josh Kinney in partnership with James De Armond.

There was also a single, non-wagering \$6,400 New York Excelsior "B" Series tilt that occurred, and **Makes Me Charlie**, by Met's Hall and bred by David Hanson, scored in 2:00.2 for driver Todd Cummings, trainer Tammy Cummings, and owners Margaret and Amy Butler.
