# How former horseplayer Garett Skiba won \$1 million betting golf

The winner of the \$1 million DraftKings World Golf Championship on why he quit betting on horses and what the industry needs to learn from Daily Fantasy Sports and others.




Long-time horseplayer Garett Skiba moved most of his play to the Daily Fantasy Sports ("DFS") space a couple of years ago, focusing primarily on golf. This past weekend he reached the pinnacle, capturing the World Fantasy Golf Championship along with its \$1 million first prize.

I contacted Skiba and he was nice enough to answer some questions regarding his pivot to DFS, gambling theory (and team or ticket making), handicapping, as well as his overall thoughts on sports gambling customer service versus what he experienced in racing.

Congratulations on this incredible accomplishment. Your winning team consisted of a mix of stars like DeChambeau and Spieth, with lower-priced alternatives like Sunjae Im. What type of strategy did you use? Is it important to handicap the opponents?

"In any zero-sum game (worse with high rake) trying to figure out what your opponents will do is pivotal to the process. Especially so with payout structures that are extraordinarily



top heavy where the equity is tied up at the top, which is typically the case with DFS. Most DFS players have models where they will project the points a golfer will earn; Vegas odds being the greatest driver of these projections. Salaries for DFS golf are released on Monday and afterwards there are typically 2-3 golfers who will become 'chalk' as their salary is underpriced relative to the odds and thus projections.

"Going into the week given where the projected ownership stood, I figured players would be going more balanced — using combinations in the \$8,000-\$9,000 range rather than going up to the 10k+ salary golfers. Remember, with everyone using the same salary cap, you can end up with a lot of clustering when it comes to lineup builds which makes differentiation difficult. As such, I pivoted to a 'stars and scrubs' approach where I jammed in Spieth and DeChambeau, and then back filled with cheaper players who were likely to be lower owned, but who still have upside. Ultimately, I was giving up projected points in exchange for diversification, so I figured it gave me a better chance of winning if I was right, but also gave me a chance to finish last If I was wrong."

Is this similar to the strategy you employed when playing the horses – either in tournament play or pick 5 or 6 betting? For the average horseplayer trying to hit more scores in serial bets in racing to become more profitable, do you have any advice, especially with things like betting value and bankroll management?

"I think part of the problem is trying to hit more scores instead trying to hit the RIGHT scores.

"There are absolutely parallels to horse racing when it comes to the concept of ownership. In any multi-race sequence, horses have two types of value:


- Horse value or the chances of winning the race. The public is very good at picking out who will win and only getting better over time. Post time favorites approaching 40 per cent is evidence of this.
- Payoff value or how much you benefit from your horse winning. The public is very poor at this concept with regards to horizontal (pick 4, 5 or 6) wagers. What horse-players should be looking at is how can we maximize our payoff when we are right. We want to find situations where the ownership, or percentage of tickets in a pick "N" pool, are inflated relative to the actual probability of winning. Horseplayers should be attempting to put themselves in situations where they benefit from the errors of other players. This can be as simple as singling in spread races and spreading in single races.

"Losing is never easy and if you play the game with the highest

EV (expected value) approach you will undoubtedly go through losing streaks/swings. Cashing tickets is a rush and feeds your ego through bragging rights, so really you have opposing ideas which conflict over the short term and long term. Over the short term, you can cash more by including more horses in a horizontal sequence. However, in the long term, that strategy will result in a lower and likely negative EV. The importance of bankroll management and playing in pools where you can withstand the swings is key. If you have a \$1,000 bankroll, playing the Pick 6 daily is going to drain your bankroll prior to giving you enough shots to take advantage of +EV play."

You have stopped gambling on horse racing for the most part. You've written that higher takeout and shorter fields (less value) as well as the "poor treatment of customers" was your main impetus to move to Daily Fantasy. Since the switch, how do you feel DFS companies have valued you as a customer? Do you believe horse racing can learn anything from them?

"It really is night and day when it comes to customer service. Even with some of the consolidation in the DFS space you have an industry that is constantly looking to develop players and invest in the long term. Granted, I play at a volume that gives me a dedicated host, but even at the lower volume levels you have daily rewards just for logging into the website. Racing, as



you won't be shocked to hear, is very much trapped in the stone ages. The web technology is beyond dated, the investment in the customer non-existent and the interest in growing the pie really is never considered.

"For example, just thinking about Breeders' Cup Betting Challenge, the marquee live bankroll tournament. You would have a significant percentage of on-track handle generated from that tournament. Instead of premium seating reflective of their contribution to the sport/handle, these folks are seated in the lowest most unattractive venue that the Breeders' Cup couldn't otherwise monetize. The gambler is an afterthought rather than a priority. My guess that has to do with some of the economics with regards to revenue splits; a dollar wagered must be split, a dollar of seating or a craft beer may be not split with the horsemen.

"Regardless, it's a situation where the writing is on the wall that future is indeed not bright. Tracks will continue to close, handle will continue to shrink in real terms, and I'm not sure what can be done at this point."

I know you've tried everything under the sun in horse race gambling, from traditional handicapping to databases and computer handicapping and have had success. Now, over the past couple of years you've had some major scores in Daily Fantasy, culminating in Monday's achievement. Was it easier for you to become a seasoned DFS player driving big handle, than it was for you to become an everyday horseplayer? Is the DFS community of businesses doing anything different as compared to horse racing?

"I've had some major scores in DFS and racing, but I've sure done my share of losing as well. I think people get so wrapped up in the red-boarding social media posting that they forget the months/years between big wins where the handle is still flowing, but the wins aren't! I think as with anything new gambling wise, there is going to be a 'tuition' that you pay in the form of losing. It comes down to how you use that tuition period to improve your process; learning from your mistakes is a key determinant if you will be successful long term.

"I've always tried to continue to refine my process, look for edges and find additional data sources that could potentially add value to my process. My advice to anyone would be to never stop trying to improve, never rest on your success, continue to work to improve.

"In terms of the differences between the two businesses, the DFS community does a great job of helping players understand the nuance of the game with regards to concepts like expected value and ownership.

"While he has the bedside manner of Dr. Kevorkian, @insidethepylons on Twitter is 100 per cent right when he criticizes the racing talking heads in their approach. Racing analysts are always focused on 'picking winners' as if that is the goal. Yes, if you are marketing to the affluent boomer looking for laughs and to cash tickets, mission accomplished. However, zero attempt is made to appeal to those millennial types who trade crypto, NFTs and want to figure out an edge in what they are doing. Teaching ticket construction, the advantages to being contrarian and that cashing the right tickets is more important that cashing more tickets, is something that is truly lacking in the industry."









#### A year after opening his own stable, Francis Dumouchel is finding success

A year ago, Francis Dumouchel gave up his job as an assistant trainer with the Blake MacIntosh stable and purchased five Ontario-sired yearlings, launching his career as a full-time standardbred trainer.

With a record of six wins, nine seconds and 12 thirds in 36 starts, for earnings of \$124,686, the launch can be considered an unqualified success for the 30-year-old horseman, who spent the last decade learning the ropes of a business that first caught his attention as a teenager.

"My mom, her brother and her sister they had a farm, and Gerry Demers was stabled there. That's how I got kind of hooked

on harness racing, because I was going to school and then I quit school to work for Gerry," said Dumouchel, who hails from Papineauville, QC. "I probably worked for him for five or six years and then I moved to Toronto with him. And then he went back home, and I decided to stay here. From that time on I worked for different trainers. I worked for Dave Menary, Luc Blais for a little bit, Tony Alagna in the summer, and then finally I worked for Blake MacIntosh. I worked for Blake for probably five years, the first two years I was a groom and the last three I was his assistant trainer."

In 2017, Dumouchel purchased Rose Run Unclebuck (Uncle Peter–Tameka Seelster) in partnership with Sophie Bourgeois' numbered company 9174 7998 Quebec Inc. of St-Janvier-Mirabel, Sylvain Descheneaux's Ecurie CSL of Sorel-Tracy and Brian Paquet of Quebec, QC. Dumouchel trained the gelding, and the additional young horses he acquired in the next two years, alongside the other MacIntosh trainees and credits his employer's generosity with his current success.

"Blake was really good to me. He'd let me train my babies, because I do mostly babies, I've just always liked doing babies, so I'd buy one or two babies and he'd let me train my babies in his sets," said Dumouchel, who currently calls Embro, ON home. "I think it helped me a lot because you know how it is, it's hard to train just one baby on his own, so having Blake letting me train with them was a big help for most of them."

In 2019, Dumouchel, Bourgeois and Descheneaux acquired Twin B Sunkissed from the Standardbred Horse Sales Company's yearling sale in Harrisburg, PA, offering up \$20,000 for the daughter of Sunshine Beach and Western Heat, and the filly's 2-year-old campaign was the catalyst for the trainer's change in employment status. The filly won an Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Gold Series leg, finished second in her Eternal Camnation division and Shes A Great Lady elimination and banked \$126,112.

Two-year-old trotting colt Luca Hanover won a division of the July 15 Grassroots season opener at Woodbine Mohawk Park and then jumped up to the Gold Series level where he finished third on July 29 and second on Aug. 19. The son of Resolve and Lady Bar makes his fifth lifetime start in a \$62,307 Champlain Stakes division on Thursday (Aug. 26 – results unavailable before the deadline for this column).

Two-year-old pacing colts Twin B Jammer (Sunshine Beach-Twin B Bikini) and He Bee Sunny (Sunshine Beach-Miss Mittzie Bee) have delivered top three performances in Grassroots and Gold Series action, respectively.

Twin B Sunkissed got off to a slow start this season, battling tie-up issues, but the sophomore pacing lass was a 1:52.3 winner in Grassroots action at Rideau Carleton Raceway on Aug. 22 and makes her ninth sophomore start in the \$169,550 Simcoe Stakes at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Saturday, Aug. 28.


"We had high expectations of her at the beginning of the year. To be honest, she's been kind of disappointing until her last two starts," said Dumouchel of Twin B Sunkissed. "They always say it's all about peaking at the right time, so hopefully she does. She's probably the best she's ever been right now, her last two starts, so hopefully she can keep going in this direction.

"Luca Hanover, I think he's a nice trotter. He was a June foal, so we don't really want to push him. Whatever he does this year is kind of a bonus, really. I've always told my owners he was going to be the one telling us if he was ready or not to race as a 2-year-old, because he's not that big and he goes through growth spurts. I don't want to over race him, seven or eight starts for him this year would be plenty.

"That Twin B Jammer colt, he's racing in the Grassroots, I think he's the most talented one we have in the barn right now. Sylvain Filion drives him, and I was telling Sylvain when he first drove him, I said, 'This horse probably has the speed of a 3-year-old right now, but he has the brain of an 18-month-old.' I think once he figures out what he needs to do he'll be a nice colt. He's nice enough already, he's a Grassroots colt, you can't really complain with a Grassroots colt, but I think once he puts everything together, he could be a really nice colt."

The other two members of his 2020 yearling class, Sportswriter fillies Twin B Fabulous and Windy Report, have been enjoying a summer vacation but will soon return to training in hopes of making their debut later this fall.

Dumouchel is stabled at the former Dreamfair Farm, just outside of Ingersoll, ON, along with Maddi and Travis Henry and he relies on the couple's formidable skills to keep his horses happy and healthy. Maddi works with the horses on a day-to-day basis and



serves as their equine massage therapist as needed. Travis is a critical set of hands in the jog cart or race bike when the babies are training down through the winter. The trio is assisted by a local young man, Gary, who is new to horses and harness racing, but has become an essential part of the team over the last year.

Looking ahead, Dumouchel hopes to return to the yearling sales this fall but said 15 horses is his maximum stable size.

"When you train horses, you kind of have to find out what's the right number for you. Some people can deal with 30, 40 horses and some people can only deal with five," Dumouchel said. "It's all about finding the number that works for you, where nobody misses anything. You want to make sure they all get taken care of like they're all world champions.

"Same with the owners, you want to keep the owners happy. I find it's a lot easier if you kind of have the same owners and they all get along, than if you have a couple of owners that disagree on stuff. My owners are great, and my staff is great, so it kind of makes everything a lot easier. If anything, I'm the one that gets grumpy when we have a bad night. The staff and the owners make it easier the next couple days on me. I put enough pressure on myself, and the owners, they know I'm just as disappointed as they are when the horses race badly."

At present, Dumouchel owns a share of all seven horses in his barn, Ecurie CSL owns a share of six, Own A Standardbred 2021 owns pieces of five and 9174 7998 Quebec Inc. and Travis Henry own shares of three. Brian Paquet still owns a piece of Rose Run Unclebuck, whose current role is paddock babysitter for Luca Hanover.

With Grand Circuit and Ontario Sires Stakes post season action on the horizon, the partners will be looking forward to seeing what the second half of Dumouchel's first season as a full-time trainer holds.

#### Gingras to Woodbine Mohawk Park on Saturday as Grand Circuit kicks off

Driver is coming to Canada off a 1:48.3 world record mile with Caviart Camden in Kentucky.

Racing this summer has seen more than its fair share of dramatic finishes in high quality stakes at tracks throughout the Midwest and East Coast, and now the Grand Circuit shifts north of the border. Beginning with the Champlain Stakes last night (Aug. 26) and continuing with stakes rich events over the next four weeks, highlighted by the Pepsi North America Cup and Mohawk Million, Woodbine Mohawk Park is about to take center stage.

The same races were conducted last year, though they took a different form considering year one of the pandemic. In addition to racing without live spectators, most U.S.-based drivers who would have made the trips otherwise, were unable to do so



Yannick Gingras will be racing at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Saturday for the start of the Grand Circuit season at the Ontario track. because of the strict protocols in place between Canada and the U.S. Now, with the harshest restrictions lifted, racing will take on a more traditional look.

Driver Yannick Gingras was one of the few U.S.-based drivers to compete at Woodbine Mohawk last September, and he makes his return there tomorrow being listed to drive in 10 of the 13 races on the Saturday card. He expects a smooth process. For the current state logistics involved in travel between borders, Gingras said, "It's always evolving, but I have dual citizenship so that's why for me, it wasn't a problem. Even though last year you had the mandatory quarantine process that you don't have to worry about now, and if you're fully vaccinated and have a negative PCR test within 72 hours then you're good to go. And it's the same thing for U.S. citizens and permanent residents, so it's pretty much open to everyone, provided you've been vaccinated."

Accordingly, traveling to race in Canada last year required a lengthy commitment, but this year drivers have the flexibility to travel up and back by the day. In fact, Gingras will be driving at The Meadows on Friday, Woodbine Mohawk on Saturday, and then back to Tioga for a 1 p.m. post time on Sunday. "Same as with the other guys too," Gingras said. "Jody (Jamieson) and Doug (McNair) were just at Scioto and Hoosier and they were able to come here and race and go back home and race the next day, it's the same thing on both sides."



Gingras' plan will be to race in the U.S. during the week and race at Woodbine Mohawk on Saturdays. One horse that could make his way to Canada that Gingras would drive is the newly crowned co-world record holder, Caviart Camden. The Huntsville 2-year-old comes off an amazing 1:48.3 mile at the Red Mile and is nominated to the Metro Pace.

"It's going to be up to Tony (Alagna) and the owners to decide what the best path is and we haven't even talked about it yet," said Gingras. "He's a very nice colt obviously, he's got really high speed, and we'll see if he makes his way up to Canada."

Sent off as the second choice at odds of 8-1 in a Kentucky Championship Series race, Caviart Camden closed from off the pace in :26.1 to beat the heavily backed Pebble Beach by a neck in that world record mile. Considering that Caviart Camden was timed individually with a :29.1 opening quarter, his effort to get to 1:48.3 can't be overstated enough. Gingras was one not caught off guard by the performance.

"The race time I was a little surprised because it was a slow first quarter, but then we were moving along really good," said Gingras. "As far as beating those horses, I wasn't surprised. His first lifetime start really impressed me, the first time I drove him, and the second week was a screw up on my part. I left when I shouldn't have and then used him too hard, so we went back to the drawing board and raced him covered up. And then the following week at Lexington he got completely taken out of the race and it wasn't his fault, so maybe those starts didn't look quite as good as he really was, but I had a lot of confidence in the horse and think he's as good as anybody."

In that 1:48.3 race at the Red Mile, there were six horses, including Caviart Camden. Five of those paced in 1:49 or better. It's a trend that we've seen time and time again where in these world record miles, there's always horses who are individually timed that – not coincidentally – exceed a faster time than anything they've dreamed of pacing or trotting previously. All horses go faster when being in a fast race.

Asked about that phenomenon, Gingras said, "My opinion is that any time you have a really hot pace, it's going to lead to fast races. These horses can go almost a whole mile at full speed, and you might get beat by the second, third, or fourth horse like exactly what happened in this race, but they can carry their speed so far at a mile these days. And the reason you don't see more 1:46 miles these days is because we don't have it in our head to go to the half in :52 or :53. If we just went all out from the start and went to the half in :52 you'd see a 1:45 mile at some point. But we have an agenda to try to rate them and save them so that the guy sitting second, third or fourth doesn't beat you. And of course, we do use them hard at times, I'm not saying that we don't, but if we just let them roll all the way you would see some scary miles. I really believe that if you had the right horse on a good hot day and on the right track, you could see a 1:45 mile no problem."

There's a number of horses that Gingras is looking forward to driving over the next month including Caviart Camden. potentially .as well as This Is The Plan and a number of exciting 2 and 3-year-olds, but one horse came first to mind. "Of course, Atlanta, I'm looking forward to racing there. She won there last year (in the Maple Leaf Trot) and it was probably the best race she's ever raced for me, she was scary good that day.

"It's a really exciting month. There's a lot of big races and this is what you work hard for, to have some power in those races. Everyone has worked for basically the last six months since the spring to get your horses to this point and the next month it's Canada and then it's onto Lexington and then the Breeders Crown. The next 10 weeks is what it's all about and hopefully we can have some."

#### Meadowlands, Tioga and Vernon Downs and Jeff Gural named in lawsuit

The Meadowlands, Tioga and Vernon Downs and Jeff Gural have been named in a lawsuit initiated by a number of standardbred owners who allege to have been excluded from racing at the three tracks as a result of their patronage of trainer Rene Allard.

Allard was among more than 30 racing related individuals indicted and arrested in March of 2020 by the United States Department of Justice for offenses relating to the systematic

and covert administration of illegal performance-enhancing drugs (PEDs) to racehorses. He was later included in a superseding indictment filed in federal court in December of 2020. The charges remain pending.

The plaintiffs named are Kapildeo Singh, Lawrence Dumain, Ira & Brian Wallach, Yves Sarrazin, Erlin Hill, Bruce Soulsby and Alan Weisenberg, who in their complaint admit that they have an interest in horses stabled by Allard in Florida over the winter of 2020-2021. The complaint alleges that the plaintiffs were the victims of a conspiracy by Gural to exclude their horses from racing at the three tracks to gain a "competitive advantage."

"It's a little discouraging that when you're trying to clean up the drug problem, we now have to hire an expensive lawyer to defend us against this lawsuit, which essentially calls me dishonest," said Meadowlands president Jeff Gural. "Worse yet, we get no cooperation from the horsemen who love to complain about the drugs but don't lift a finger to help us catch the perpetrators. The lawsuit is without merit. We will vigorously defend against these allegations and look forward to being vindicated in court."

#### See you in September

The Meadowlands is usually dark in September, but for the second straight year, thanks to COVID-19, they'll be back to work on Labor Day weekend.

In 2020, following a three-month, sport-wide pandemic shut-down, The Big M raced some of those cancelled dates in September. This year, they are doing it to make up for dates that typically would be raced on Thursdays in December.

The Thursdays were primarily raced in the past to accommodate corporate holiday parties but since dates needed to be arranged before the end of last year, the track erred on the side of caution.

"Not knowing what the outcome would be of the pandemic, where we would be at, it was important to us to be able to get a schedule out there," said Jason Settlemoir, chief operating officer and general manager of The Meadowlands.

"With the eliminations for the Breeders Crown and finals for the Breeders Crown, you're eliminating overnight races, so we wanted to give the horsemen an opportunity to be able to race those additional races," said Settlemoir. "It also has to do with our group sales. We picked up those first two Thursdays simply because they're the best two days to add onto our calendar."



# Melander duo looks for success in Zweigs

Dancinginthedark M will try to return to his winning ways Saturday (Aug. 28) when he meets eight foes in the \$325,000 Dr. Harry M. Zweig Memorial for 3-year-old trotters at Vernon Downs. The colt, who posted impressive victories in the weeks prior to the Hambletonian, went off stride in his Hambletonian elimination last month and failed to advance to the final.

The week following his Hambletonian elimination, Dancinginthedark M made a break near the finish line and was second in the Muscle Hill. He heads to the Zweig off a second-place finish in the second round of the Kentucky Championship Series at Lexington's Red Mile, where he remained trotting throughout the mile.

"I wasn't really happy with him making breaks two weeks in a row, so it was nice for him to get a good confidence race in Kentucky, even if he was second," trainer Marcus Melander said. "He was very strong crossing the wire. I think he's as ready as he can be."

Melander believes Dancinginthedark M's break in the Hambletonian elimination was the result of the colt hitting a knee. In the Muscle Hill, the horse raced without shoes up front and got pacey at the end of the race. Jujubee won the Muscle Hill in a Meadowlands track record of 1:49.4. Dancinginthedark M was timed in 1:50.

"It was a huge disappointment he didn't make the final in the Hambletonian," Melander said. "He can lean in a little bit in the turns and probably hit his knee because the speed was picking up in the last turn.

"Of course, the Hambletonian is the (sport's) biggest race, and we all want to win it. Sadly, it wasn't our year with him. We just try to forget it and move on."

Prior to the Hambletonian elimination, Dancinginthedark M won a division of the Stanley Dancer Memorial in 1:50.1 over a Meadowlands track labeled "good" and a division of the W.N. Reynolds Memorial in 1:51.4 over a sloppy surface.

Dancinginthedark M will start the Zweig from post four with driver Tim Tetrick and is the 5-2 morning-line favorite. For the year, the son of Readly Express—Leila has won four of eight races and \$128,847 for breeder/owner Menhammar Stuteri AB. Lifetime, the colt has seven victories and three second-place finishes in 15 starts, good for \$220,808.

"I'm confident in my horse," Melander said. "He was the favorite leading up to the Hambletonian and he's beaten these horses before. If he stays flat, I think he has a good shot. I think he's the best horse in the field and we've got a good post. That's very important too."

Paul Kelley-trained Balenciaga, coming off a win over Ahundreddollarbill and Ambassador Hanover in a division of the New York Sire Stakes, is the 7-2 second choice. Ake Svanstedt's Ambassador Hanover, who was third in the Hambletonian, is 4-1.

Prior to the Zweig's open division, Melander will send out Iteration

in the \$140,000 Zweig Memorial for 3-year-old filly trotters. She is the 7-2 second choice behind 5-2 Darlene Hanover, who won the Delmonica Hanover Stakes last weekend.

Iteration, by Chapter Seven out of Steamy Windows, has won nine of 18 career races and \$633,292 for owner Courant Inc. Her wins include last season's New York Sire Stakes championship for 2-year-old filly trotters and this year's New York New York Mile and a division of the Empire Breeders Classic.

She was second in both her elimination and the final of the Hambletonian Oaks. She started the Oaks from post 10 at The Meadowlands.

"From the 10 hole, it almost felt like a win from our perspective," Melander said. "She was ready that day. We pulled all her shoes; that might have helped a little bit."

Prior to the Oaks elimination, Iteration suffered her only finishes worse than second this year. She was fourth in a New York Sire Stakes event at Tioga Downs and went off stride behind the gate in a division of the Delvin Miller Memorial and was seventh.

"At Tioga, we hoped it was the track that day," Melander said. "I don't think she got enough grip and she got tired because of that. We couldn't find any sickness. In the Delvin Miller, we closed her up a little (with her bridle) and she got too aggressive behind the gate, so we put an open bridle back on her."

Iteration enters the Zweig off a New York Sire Stakes victory at Saratoga.

"There are some nice fillies in this race, but she is one of the contenders, for sure," Melander said. "She's a very nice filly. You don't make over six-hundred thousand if you're not a nice filly. She's a real sweetheart, nice to drive and everything. We've got a good post. It will be exciting. She's done everything we've asked of her."



#### HP Mama B and Imextraspecial rip up Canadian records in Elora

Grand River Raceway fans were treated to a gorgeous August evening and a pair of sizzling performances by the 3-year-old trotting fillies on Wednesday (Aug. 25).

At post time the Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) and Canadian record was 1:55.4, set by Bright Eyes M at Grand River Raceway in 2019 and equalled by Massive Flirt at Flamboro Downs in 2020. Wednesday, by 9 p.m., it had been lowered by the winners of both Gold Series divisions. **HP Mama B** stripped three-fifths of a second off the record in the first split and **Imextraspecial** dropped it by another fraction in the second.

HP Mama B and driver Sylvain Filion lined up at Post 5 in the \$100,600 opener and found themselves parked in the outer lane through a :27.4 quarter clocked by You Will Be Queen. The fan favorites made their way to the front before the :56.2 half and by the 1:25.3 three-quarters HP Mama B had opened up two lengths on her peers. In the stretch she extended that margin to three lengths, stopping the clock in a record-setting 1:55.1. You Will Be Queen finished second and Dicentra was another length back in fourth. (replay here: HP Mama B)

"She had to work for it tonight, well she comes to race all the time, but she worked pretty hard, she had enough at the wire

tonight," said trainer Ben Baillargeon, who was concerned about how the Royalty For Life daughter would handle Wednesday's heat and humidity. "This is the only thing that worried me was the weather. I hardly warmed her up tonight, I didn't want to do too much with her, but she raced good. She overcame it, sign of a good mare."

HP Mama B was also victorious in the July 1 Gold Series season opener at Woodbine Mohawk Park and the July 17 leg at Georgian Downs. She finished second in the third leg to Imextraspecial. The Royalty For Life daughter also has two wins in Woodbine Mohawk Park overnight action to her credit, the first on June 18 and the most recent in a personal best 1:53.1 on Aug. 16.

Baillargeon, who also bred HP Mama B, trains the winner of \$296,287 for his wife Guylaine Picard of Guelph, ON and their family friend Celine Paquin of Ayers Cliff, QC.

Three races later Trevor Henry and Imextraspecial left smartly from Post 6 and found themselves parked to a :27.4 opening quarter. Once Imextraspecial had established command, Arthur, ON resident Henry dialed the tempo back through a :57 half and 1:26.2 three-quarters, and then the filly dug in for a stretch battle that saw her flanked on the right and left by Hawaii and Midnight Miracle. Imextraspecial kept a stubborn neck in front for the 1:55 record-setting score, leaving the challengers to settle for second and third, respectively (replay here: Imextraspecial)

"Every trip is not going to be easy. Sometimes you get the good hole, good trip, but it was not the case tonight. She had to work her butt off to get to the front, and fortunate enough Trevor got them shut down a bit and we could hang on," said trainer Paul Walker, whose primary concern was whether the filly would be sharp enough coming off a three week break. "I was trying to look ahead a little bit, she's got tough races the next four weeks, and I just thought, well I'm going to take a chance and see if I can get her tight enough to do the job. You hope you make the

right decision, but you don't know at the time. A good horse will bail a trainer out most times."

Imextraspecial's Gold Series wins came at Georgian Downs on July 17 and Woodbine Mohawk Park on Aug. 6. She finished second to HP Mama B in the July 1 season opener. In addition to her Gold wins, the Muscle Mass daughter was a winner in overnight action at Woodbine Mohawk Park on July 26.

Owen Sound resident Walker trains the winner of \$444,178 for owner Keith Coulter of Mono, ON. Imextraspecial also set a track, Ontario Sires Stakes and Canadian record in Gold Series action as a 2-year-old. That record was lowered earlier this summer by Adare Castle.

So long as they remain happy and healthy, Gold Series co-leaders HP Mama B and Imextraspecial will make their next start in the Sept. 3 Casual Breeze stake at Woodbine Mohawk Park. Imextraspecial is also eligible to the Sept. 18 Elegantimage, which will be limited to the 10 horses with the highest lifetime earnings at the time of entry, and the Sept. 25 Simcoe Stakes.

"Casual Breeze next week, she'll hopefully be in the hunt for something," said Walker. "Hopefully we can give the Americans a bit of a tussle. They always come with some pretty good horses, that's for sure."

The 3-year-old trotting fillies will return to Gold Series action on Sept. 28 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Another trotter that created a lot of buzz was Castyourcrown, consigned by Tye Loy. The competitive Ohio stakes placed 3-year-old son of Dontyouforgetit was purchased by Blake Daniels of Ohio.

Burke Racing Stable always brings a nice consignment and this one featured the fancy Ohio stakes eligible 3-year-old pacing fillies Pinknperfect by Well Said and Winella Hanover by Racing Hill. Bidding was spirited as both were out of very strong families with obvious broodmare value. In the end, Daniel Schrock got Pinknperfect for \$32,000 and Tim Troyer got Winella Hanover for \$28,000. # Mon Cheval shows royal bloodlines in PASS win

Parked the entire opening three-eighths from post 7, Mon Cheval called on the talent and determination of her royal ancestors and made the challenge look easy, capturing a division of Thursday's (Aug. 26) \$162,110 Pennsylvania Sires Stake for freshman filly trotters. Dreamonhigh charged through the Lightning Lane to take the other split in the event known as the Delmonica Hanover.

Both Mon Cheval and Dreamonhigh appear to have locked up slots in the championship. The Meadows will play host to all four \$250,000 PASS finals for 2-year-olds on Friday, Sept. 3.

Mon Cheval's sire (Father Patrick) and second dam (Solveig) are in the Harness Hall of Fame while her dam, Shake It Cerry, was the 2014 Trotter Of The Year. Those regal bloodlines showed Thursday when Mon Cheval overcame the challenging trip to score in 1:55.3 for Dexter Dunn, a length better than Perfect Helen, who now has finished second in all five career starts and also will advance to the PASS championship. Tie One On completed the ticket.

Nancy Takter, who conditions the homebred for Solveig's Racing Partners, said she wasn't terribly concerned with the demanding opening panel plus.

"She's a tough filly," Takter said. "We train our horses a lot like that, so they're kind of used to it."

Could it be that Mon Cheval is destined to join her ancestors in the Hall of Fame?

"She has a little bit more to prove on the racetrack, but she's heading in the right direction," Takter said.

Winning driver Ronnie Wrenn, Jr. piloted Dreamonhigh to a place finish in the July 29 Arden Downs at The Meadows, and he picked up some valuable information that he used in the Delmonica Hanover.

"She's real funny about her mouth," Wrenn said. "Last time I let her trot a pretty good clip and didn't rate her that well, and I got beat on the end of it. Today I watched her out of the gate, and when I got her in the two hole, she was really relaxed. Down the stretch she was full of trot."

Indeed, the daughter of Andover Hall—RC's Dream was straight and swift as she poured through the Lightning Lane to down the rallying Baptist by a length in a career-best 1:55.2. Early leader Pink Gypsy earned show.

Jennifer Bongiorno trains Dreamonhigh for KAT Stables.

Born On Third Base stretched her career unbeaten streak to five with a victory in Thursday's Pennsylvania Stallion Series. Although the daughter of Donato Hanover—Housethatruthbuilt was looped from the gate by Money Matters, she had little trouble defeating that rival by two lengths, with Miss Principle third.

"I didn't want to rush her into the first turn too hard. I knew she would have enough speed to keep moving forward," said winning driver Dunn. "I think she has a lot of potential. All her wins have been pretty easy. She's not paid into much this year, so she'll get a good break and come back as a good 3-year-old."

Shestheluckyone and I'll Have A Lindy also took divisions, each with Yannick Gingras aboard. In an oddity, all three winners were clocked in 1:56.2.

Live racing at The Meadows continues today (Aug. 27) when the 13-race card features a pair of carryovers — \$34,833.19 in the final-race Super Hi-5, \$1,076.22 in the Pick 5 (race 8). On the racing front, the program offers a pair of events for freshman colt and gelding pacers, including a \$159,745 Pennsylvania Sires Stake and a \$40,000 PA Stallion Series event. First post is 12:45 PM.

# Freshmen trotters shine in ISS at Harrah's Hoosier Park

The focus was on the freshmen at Harrah's Hoosier Park on Wednesday (Aug. 25). A total of five divisions of Indiana Sire Stakes would highlight the 14-race card, three divisions for 2-year-old trotting colts and geldings, as well as two for the 2-year-old trotting fillies.

The undefeated **Ponda Adventure** would kick things off in the \$44,500 first division for 2-year-old trotting colts and geldings. Winning in front end fashion for the potent Trace Tetrick and Erv Miller combination, scoring the victory by four lengths on the line over Words As Weapons S and Summit City Sonny in 1:54.2. The gelded son of Swan For All was bred by Pond-a-acres, and is the first foal by the quarter million dollar earing Muscle Hill mare, Wildflower. Ponda Adventure is now a perfect five for

five to kick off his young career, pushing his career earnings to \$94,968 on the season for owners LAWillinger, JD Graham and Engel Stables of ILLC.

In the second division for trotting colts, the undefeated **Dover In Motion** would follow suit and extend his unbeaten streak to four to begin his career. Leaving from post 4, Dover In Motion would stay patient in the early going for driver Ricky Macomber Jr. before making a backstretch brush from third, clearing to the lead and never looking back for the remainder of the mile. Dover In Motion would check out on the field in the stretch, cruising to seven length 1:54.4 victory over second choice Yo Mister and longshot Gustavo Flight. Jamie Macomber trains the gelded son of first crop sire Dover Dan for owners M&M Racing and Norbert Joseph Maza. Bred by Lyle Dean Slabach, the \$50,000 Hoosier Classic purchase now boasts earnings of \$88,750 through his perfect four career starts.

The third and final division of Stakes action for the trotting colts would prove to be much closer at the line, with **Swan Captain** and John De Long getting up by a neck in a thrilling three-across finish. Utilizing a sharp :27.2 final quarter, Swan Captain would ride the rail to get up in time in 1:57.4 over the upset minded Land Of Freedom and Dale Hiteman. Muscle Valley and Ricky Macomber Jr. would rally late on the far outside to narrowly miss and round out the trifecta ticket third. Trained by Roger Welch, Swan Captain was a \$100,000 purchase from the 2020 Hoosier Classic Yearling Sale for owners Willam C De Long, William P De Long & Gordon Wright. This evening's Sire Stakes score came as the maiden breaking victory for the gelded son of Swan For All out of the Muscles Yankee mare, Yoga. Swan Captain scored the mild 7-1 upset, returning \$16.20 for his backers at the betting window.

The trotting fillies would kick their night off with the \$66,000 first division of Sire Stakes as the evening's ninth race. After being parked three-deep in the first turn, **Simply Right** and Elliot Deaton would land in the pocket on the backstretch and convert the trip into an open length 1:57 score. Sent off by the betting public at 5-1, Simply Right nabbed a three length victory over race favorite Macy, with Luv Lorelei and Robert Taylor getting up for third from the second tier in post 10. Simply Right was an \$87,000 purchase at the Lexington Select Yearling sale for owner Al Libfeld of Ontario. Bred by Alan and Larry Troyer of Indiana, Simply Right is a Swan For All full sister to Indiana Sire Stakes winner Shirley Goodness, out of the Credit Winner mare Stirling Debutant. Anette Lorentzon trains the rookie trotting filly, getting the first win of her career in her third lifetime start and now banking over \$50,000 on the season in doing so.

Sire Dover Dan would pick up his second Sire Stakes victory on the evening, with **Callmesue** and taking the \$66,000 second split for trotting fillies. Callmesue would make good on the pocket trip given by driver/trainer James Yoder, holding off a hard charging M-M's Dream by a slim nose, with previously undefeated and bettor's choice, Fleurie, finishing a quarter length back in third. The pint sized filly by the Mr Lavec mare, Lisas Mission, has visited the winner's circle in five of six starts on the season,

trotting to a lifetime mark of 1:55.3 in this evening's 12th race. Bred by Richard Frey, Callmesue was a \$14,000 Hoosier Classic purchase by the husband and wife team of James and Cheyenne Yoder, who are no strangers to top Indiana Trotting Fillies with the likes of stable star and Indiana Sire Stakes champion, May Baby. Callmesue has now brought in \$87,750 on the season for her connections.

# New whipping rules underway in Quebec

The Quebec Racing Commission has approved the final changes in the new whipping rules that went into effect Thursday (Aug. 26).

The new rules will be strictly enforced by the judges. Horsepeople in Quebec have been properly notified of these changes well in advance of Thursday's start.

The new whipping rules call for the following:

Section 194 of the Horse Racing Rules Standardbred breed held on a professional racetrack (chapter C-72.1, r. 5) is amended by:

1. the whip replacement of "of a total length 4 'and 8', including a cord whose length is may not exceed 8" by "the handle of which is a maximum length of 48" and a cord measuring between 6 "and 12" in length.

"The whip must not be made of leather and its popper cord must not have been altered or knotted."

2.Article 195 of the rules is replaced by the following: "195. The driver, trainer or caretaker cannot use a whip on a racing track in any abusive way. He should not also use his whip in any of the following ways: 1 - by touching the horse with the handle of his whip; 2 - by placing his whip under the arch of the sulky; 3 - by placing his whip between the legs of the horse. He can only use a whip to stimulate the horse by performing a wrist movement. In addition, the movement of the whip can only be executed between the drawbars of the sulky."

3. These rules are amended by inserting, after the following section 195: "195.1. A driver, trainer or groom should not use a whip in the following situations: a) the horse does not respond to whip stimulation; b) the horse can no longer improve its position in the race; c) the horse does not maintain or is not in the process of improving its position in the race; d) the horse is on the way to winning; e) the horse has passed the finish post at the end of the race; f) in such a way as to cut it or leave marks on it "

4. Article 199 of these rules is amended by: 2 - the addition, at the end, of the following paragraph: "The driver must not kick his horse during a race."

#### Sweet Soul David widens Grassroots lead

**Sweet Soul David** jumped out to a commanding lead in the 3-year-old trotting colt standings with his third Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Grassroots victory in the first of three \$21,000-plus divisions at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Tuesday (Aug. 24).

Driver Louis-Philippe Roy fired the fan favorite away from Post 4 and Sweet Soul David led the field through fractions of :28.2, :59 and 1:28.1. Emerald Wings, Harry and Walkonthemoon tried to reel in the pacesetter in the stretch, but Sweet Soul David dug in for a neck victory in 1:56.1. Emerald Wings finished second and Harry was third in the \$21,800 opener. (replay here: Sweet Soul David)

"He's not a big horse, but he's really slick gaited. His future is probably on a half-mile track when he gets older," said Roy, adding that the gelding is probably not at his best on the front end. "I was parked in Rideau the whole way with him, just sitting with him, and when I asked him he chased them pretty hard so I feel like he's better chasing. On the front he's kind of waiting on them a little bit, that's probably why last time I beat him with Four Wheelin."

In addition to Tuesday's victory, Roy also piloted the Kadabra gelding to victory in the July 3 Grassroots season opener at Hiawatha Horse Park and the July 11 leg at Rideau Carleton Raceway. In the Aug. 10 event at Woodbine Mohawk Park, the Guelph, ON resident opted for Four Wheelin and the pair caught Sweet Soul David and driver Sylvain Filion in the final strides. With a record of three wins and one second, Sweet Soul David has accumulated 175 points toward a berth in the Oct. 1 Grassroots Semi-Finals, 63 points ahead of his nearest rival.

Patrick Lang of Ancaster trains Sweet Soul David for his co-owners Simon Swindells of Little Britain, Garth Bechtel of Meaford and Paul Kleinpaste of Orangeville, ON.

**Tokyo Seelster** got his first win of 2021 in the second \$22,150 Grassroots division. Also starting from Post 4, Tokyo Seelster settled in fourth as favorite Highland Mowgli led the field to a :27.4 quarter and a :57 half. Highland Mowgli powered to a 1:25.3 three-quarters, but driver Doug McNair and Tokyo Seelster were one the move and had collared the pacesetter by the top of the stretch. Diehard Seelster mounted a late challenge, but Tokyo Seelster hung on for a nose victory in a personal best 1:55.1. Pocket-sitter Rosies War Bonds finished third. (**replay here: Tokyo Seelster**)

"He was a great 2-year-old, I couldn't wait for him to finally get his picture taken at three," said Puslinch, ON resident Richard Moreau, who trains the Kadabra gelding for Michael and Sam Sergi of Canton, NY and Braveheart Racing of Ottawa, ON. "He has everything for him to be a good horse; he's just had a disappointing year."

A two-time Gold Series winner at two, Tokyo Seelster started his sophomore campaign at that level, but could not crack the top three. Before Tuesday's win the Kadabra son's best finish through seven starts was a runner-up effort in a July 19 overnight.

The Prince also benefitted from a move down to the Grassroots in the third \$21,800 division. Starting from Post 5 driver Paul MacDonell sent the heavy favorite straight to the front and The Prince rolled through fractions of :28.2, :57.2 and 1:26.3 on his way to a personal best 1:54.4. Arlanda and Stonebridge Armour finished three lengths back in second and third. (replay here: The Prince)

Chantal Mitchell trains The Prince for her partners in Party Don't Stop Racing of Waterdown, ON and Imagine Stable of L'Ange-Gardien, QC and opted to start the gelding's provincial career in the Aug. 9 Gold Leg at Woodbine Mohawk Park. The Prince finished a hard-closing sixth, but with the post season looming Mitchell decided a move to the Grassroots was in order.

"If it would have been two divisions (Aug. 9) I think he had a shot at getting a good check in there, but being one division and never having raced in stakes, Paul (MacDonell) took a more conservative approach. He put him behind Macho Martini, who was a good horse to follow, but the trip just didn't really work out," said Mitchell. "If I knew it was only going to be seven horses (in the Gold) yesterday I would have put him in, but we've got to get points if we want to make one of the finals."

The Prince was late arriving to the OSS program due to an extended growth spurt in his 2-year-old year and Mitchell is hoping that the slow start will benefit the trotter over what she hopes will be a long career.

"We liked him last year training and then when he got into that growth spurt, he'd get uneven, I'd give him a couple weeks, and then he'd even out, and then he'd be uneven again. So I said, 'You know what, I don't want to push this horse. If we turn him out now and let him grow, I think he has the talent to be a good racehorse," said Mitchell. "So we're just trying to look after him and then hopefully we have a nice racehorse in the long run."

The trainer and her partners now face a decision heading into the last leg. To be eligible for the Grassroots Semi-Final horses must have two regular season starts under their belt. Qualifying for the Gold Series Super Final requires two regular season starts or minimum of 50 points. The last Grassroots Leg goes postward Sept. 20, while the last Gold Series event is scheduled for Oct. 4, both at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

# **Zweig Memorial at Vernon Downs**

The **Dr. Harry M. Zweig** Memorial Trot, a Grand Circuit stake that is "Open to the World", will be raced on Saturday (Aug. 28) at historic Vernon Downs.

The open division will race for a purse of \$325,000 as race nine on the card, just after the fillies vie for \$140,000 in the eighth.

Steeped in history, the Zweig has long been an important stop on the Grand Circuit for sophomore trotters. Last year, Hambletonian winner Ramona Hill won the Zweig filly division while Hambletonian runner up Ready For Moni won the open split.

This year's editions are among the most competitive in recent memory with nine talented square gaiters taking their positions behind the mobile starting barrier in both races.

Spy Booth is an trotting anomaly, having the distinction of finishing second in the 2021 Hambletonian and amassing more than \$250,000 in career earnings while never actually winning a race. The altered son of Muscle Hill would be the first to break maiden in the Zweig, but certainly must be considered.

Owners John Fielding, David Anderson, Robert LeBlanc and Marvin Katz ponied up \$460,000 for Spy Booth as a yearling from breeder Order By Stable. Their fortunes rest in the formidable hands of 2020's top training and driving duo of Nancy Takter and Dexter Dunn.

Balenciaga (Scott Zeron) is new to the party but has been coming to hand quickly for trainer Paul Kelley and presents a real threat. He snapped the winning skein of current NYSS division leader Ahundreddollarbill right on the wire at Tioga just a week ago and did it the right way. SRF Stable and breeder Crawford Farms share ownership in this Chapter Seven gelding.

Ambassador Hanover will contend for Team Svanstedt from post 3 while Dancinginthedark M seeks to return to the form that had him at the top of "The Road to the Hambletonian" list for the Melander barn.

The filly race is at least as contentious as the colts with Darlene Hanover coming in as the "Hot Filly" for trainer Brett Bittle. The Chapter Seven lass has a win over the course when she took a division of the Empire Breeders Classic back in June and was a convincing winner of the Delmonica Hanover in her last. Yankeeland Partnership owns Darlene, who will eclipse a half

million in career earnings with a good showing on Saturday. Todd McCarthy has the drive.

Iteration (Brian Sears) is the reigning queen of the NYSS program and has proven on more than one occasion to be of Grand Circuit caliber, including a hard fought second in the Hambletonian Oaks. Another Chapter Seven, Iteration cost owner Courant, INC. a cool quarter million as a yearling put has already returned over \$600,000 in dividends. Marcus Melander is the trainer.

Three divisions of the New York Sires Stakes for freshman filly trotters will support the features.

First post on Saturday at Vernon is 6:10pm.

# Grand Circuit another avenue to rewards for Ontario breeders

Grand Circuit action gets under way in Ontario this week and the province's standardbred breeders stand to profit if their Ontario Bred progeny achieve success against the best trotters and pacers in North America.

All breeders who enrolled their broodmares in the 2018 and 2019 Ontario Resident Mare Program (ORMP) will be eligible for the rewards associated with the designated open stake events, and those that bred their mares to Ontario Sires are also eligible for rewards connected to the Ontario Sires Stakes program. In total the 2021 Ontario Bred rewards program is worth upwards of \$2.6 million.

"The (ORMP) program is a great program. I believe it's the best in the business. With our strong sires stakes program, the rewards are excellent," said Pat Woods, manager of Winbak Farm of Canada, currently the leading breeder in the 2021 Ontario Sires Stakes program. "On some of your yearlings that you may sell at a breakeven point, when they go on and race and do well and you get some breeder's rewards on it, it actually can be your profit margin."

Winbak Farm enrolls all of their Ontario-based broodmares in the ORMP program each year, whether they are bred to Ontario or U.S.-based stallions. Each top five finish by the 2- and 3-year-old offspring of those Ontario Resident Mares in Ontario Sires Stakes and/or Grand Circuit stakes action contributes to their breeder's awards. The rewards the Winbak-bred youngsters accumulate are then funnelled back into the Ontario operation.

"Sometimes they allow us to do some projects that are on the wish list and not the necessity list. Whether it be an upgrade of a tractor, or an upgrade of a truck, or improving our broodmare band," said Woods. "When we have more successful seasons, those go a long way to helping improve our product."

Breeders can enroll their broodmares in the program at any

point before Sept.1 of each foaling year. Before the mare foals the cost to enrol is \$100. After foaling the fee increases to \$300 and third party proof of residency and foaling in Ontario are required. Mares must reside in Ontario for a minimum of 180 days surrounding foaling.

"Any of our clients that foal mares out here, we encourage every single one of them to enroll in the program, and to date I think all of them have," said Woods. "And they do understand the rewards and the benefits behind doing that."

Among the horses that are contributing to Winbak Farm of Canada's 2021 rewards are 3-year-old pacing colt Desperate Man (Shadow Play), 2-year-old pacing colts Camealongway (Sportswriter), and Kolby Two Step (Betterthancheddar), 2-year-old trotting colt Mr Fritter (Muscle Mass) and 3-year-old pacing fillies Game Of Shadows (Shadow Play) and Shes Got It All (Bettors Delight). The Winbak Farm team will be cheering on each of the youngsters as they test their skills in open stake events over the next four weeks.

#### A star in Canada, True Blue Lindy makes U.S. debut in today's PASS

True Blue Lindy is an Always B Miki gelding out of the Yankee Cruiser mare Think Pink. That makes him Pennsylvania bred, yet he's never set foot on a Pennsylvania track. That will change today (Aug. 27) when he contests a \$159,745 Pennsylvania Sires stake for 2-year-old colt and gelding pacers — the final preliminary leg in the series — at The Meadows in one stab to qualify for the championship.

True Blue Lindy goes from the rail in race 10 with Tim Tetrick piloting for trainer Jeff Cullipher, who owns the youngster with Pollack Racing LLC. Friday's program also features a \$60,000 PA Stallion Series event for freshman colt and gelding pacers. First post is 12:45 PM.

The Meadows will play host to all four \$250,000 PASS championships for 2-year-olds on Friday, Sept. 3.

True Blue Lindy has raced all five career starts at Woodbine Mohawk, where he sparkled for then-owners Carl Jamieson, William Loyens and Trevor Edwards. He captured the Aug. 8 final of the Dream Maker Series to lift his bankroll to \$55,638. He's never been worse than second, and no horse in today's field has gone faster than his mark of 1:51.2.

Pollack scouted the horse and, 10 days ago, he and Cullipher purchased him privately. He's seen plenty of America now, as his travels took him first to Gaitway Farm in New Jersey, then to Cullipher's base at Hoosier Park and now to The Meadows.

Despite his obvious talent, a big question remains: with all previous starts on a seven-eighths-mile track, how will he handle The Meadows' five-eighths-mile oval? Cullipher, who has sat behind the horse for exactly one training trip, is confident True Blue Lindy will make a successful transition.

"He likes to go forward, and he seems versatile," Cullipher says. "That's what it takes on a five-eighths-mile track."

Even a win might not guarantee True Blue Lindy a spot in the PASS championship, but Cullipher indicates they'll be all out for that victory.

"We aren't going there to race easy," he says. "We're looking for a tough race, and he'll be racing tough. I assume Timmy will forwardly place him; we need the points."

And Cullipher and Pollack are looking beyond the PASS final, rich though it may be.

"We hope to get some of our money back this year," Cullipher says, "but more importantly, we hope he'll turn out to be a top stakes colt next year."
