Talented trio tackles Ohio Sire Stakes finals

Nation's leading trainer, Ron Burke, looks to pad his lead by sending out 11 pupils in the \$2.4 million OHSS finals tonight at Northfield Park.

Trainer Ron Burke is no stranger to big chances in big events and with 11 starters in the eight Ohio Sire Stakes (OHSS) Finals Sunday night at MGM Northfield Park, Burke is looking forward to another big night.

Included in his roster of OHSS finalist are a trio of talented 2-year-olds — **Elver Hanover**, who is undefeated this season; **It's Academic**, who swept the preliminary legs; and the world champion, **Looksgoodinaromper**.

Owned by Burke Racing Stable, Dr. Bridgette Jablonsky, Jason Melillo and J&T Silva – Prunel & Libby, Elver Hanover has been perfect in his five seasonal starts, including all four preliminary legs and the Ohio State Fair stakes.

"He just seems to do everything well. A couple of times he overcame tough trips and still got there. He seems to have a nose for the winner's circle," said Burke.

A \$50,000 yearling purchase, the gelded son of Yankee Cruiser has earned \$106,500 this season and has to overcome several outside posts to keep his winning streak alive. Elver Hanover drew post #2 in Sunday's \$300,000 final and Burke was excited to see his post draw luck change.

"Especially when Danny (Noble's) colt (Ocean Rock) went that big mile last week. We definitely did not want to be starting too far behind him," Burke said.

Elver Hanover was bred by Hanover Shoe Farm and their executive vice president/syndicate manager, Dr. Bridgette Jablonsky purchased a part of the gelding.

"I guess she just likes his personality," said Burke. "He is like a big pet. She was worried that he wouldn't be a good horse because he was a big pet. But that has never affected him.

"When we first started training him down he was just a little bit disinterested at points. He is a Yankee Cruiser and we already have a Yankee Cruiser stallion (Sweet Lou), so we went ahead and gelded him."

In the 2-year-old colt trot, Burke will send It's Academic postward as the morning line choice from post #4. The Uncle Peter colt has won five of six starts, the only blemish was a result of a break before the start in the Ohio State Fair Stakes on August 1 at Scioto Downs.

"I think as much as anything (the break) was because of the nine hole. The nine hole there at Scioto, for a young

Burke appeals second positive in Ohio for Class 3 drug

Harness racing's leading money-winning trainer Ron Burke of Canonsburg, PA, has appealed a \$1,000 fine and 90-day suspension from the Ohio State Racing Commission (OSRC) after his trainee **McBoogitty** tested positive for Class 3 drug Gabapentin after winning an \$8,000 overnight on July 18 of this year at Scioto Downs.

It is the second positive for Gabapentin a Burke trainee has received in Ohio in a little more than eight months. On Nov. 12, 2018, Burke's pupil **Rock N Tony** tested positive for Gabapentin after winning a \$10,500 overnight at Northfield Park. Burke was fined \$1,000 and suspended 30 days for that infraction.

The appeal of McBoogitty's positive allows Burke to race in tonight's rich Ohio Sires Stakes finals at Northfield Park, in which he will send out 11 horses.

WebMD.com said in humans Gabapentin, "is used with other medications to prevent and control seizures. It is also used to relieve nerve pain following shingles (a painful rash due to herpes zoster infection) in adults. Gabapentin is known as an anticonvulsant or antiepileptic drug."

Burke, the leading trainer in harness racing history by a wide margin with more than 10,000 wins and purse earnings of more than \$225 million, is also the leading trainer in wins and money in 2019 with 661 and nearly \$13 million, respectively, through Friday (Aug. 30).

horse, they have to go right by the paddock. I think he thought about going into the paddock,” admitted Burke.

It's Academic was purchased for \$50,000 as a yearling by Burke Racing Stable, W. Donovan, Joe Sbrocco and Hatfield Stables from GBW Breeding Farm.

The colt owns a 1:56.2 mark at Scioto Downs and has earned \$83,400.

Rounding out the freshman trio is Looksgoodinaromper. Burke Racing Stable shares ownership of the Pet Rock filly with Weaver Brussemi.

Looksgoodinaromper has improved in each 2019 start. She finished third in the first leg, second by a nose in the second leg and has rattled off three straight wins.

On Aug. 9 in the final OHSS leg, she came from off the pace to score a one length victory in 1:52.4 to establish a new Northfield mark and world record.

“Looklikearomper looks like the best one of the three. She set a world record (at Northfield),” noted Burke. “She seems to do things that most horses don’t do.”

Looklikearomper will leave from post #6 and was made the 3-1 second choice.

All three of Burke's top 2-year-olds will be driven by Mt. Vernon, OH native Chris Page.

“Chris has done a great job with all the babies this year,” said Burke. “All three of my best ones are all versatile and can race from anywhere.”

Burke will also have six 3-year-olds completing Sunday night, but he is less enthusiastic with the chances of the sextet.

“This year my (Ohio-bred) 2-year-olds are better than my 3-year-olds. My 3-year-olds still have chances, but my 2-year-olds are more advanced.”

With a 16 race card and more than \$2.5 million in purse money being distributed over the evening, Ohio Super Night will be the richest night of racing in MGM Northfield Park's history. First race post time is 6:00 p.m. (EST) and the OSS Finals will be races 7 through 14.

Erv Miller's gamble will make for fascinating viewing in tonight's Ohio championships

A record \$2.5 million in purses will be paid out tonight at Northfield Park on a card featuring eight \$300,000 Ohio Sires Stakes championship races.

Gambling at racetracks isn't restricted to the dreamers in the grandstand and clubhouse. There is also the backstretch bunch, owners and trainers that risk tens of thousands of dollars on the pedigrees and promise of the horses that occupy their barns

An intriguing example of how packets of money fly through the air will be on display Sunday when the richest night in

the history of northeast Ohio racing goes postward at Northfield Park. An eye-popping \$2,485,300 in purses will be rewarded with most of it being distributed in eight \$300,000 Ohio Sires Stakes (OHSS) championship races.

Of particular interest is the sophomore trotting filly championship, because the mile dash will test the judgement of Erv Miller, one of the top horsemen in North America, and the partnership of Buckeye owners Carl Howard of Powell and Joyce Ann McClelland of Zanesville, OH.

Until Tuesday, Uncle Peters Love, an entrant in the aforementioned juvenile filly trot, raced for Miller. Five days and one hammer drop later, she'll strut her stuff for Howard and McClelland.

That's because Miller, despite the fact that Uncle Peters Love had won three of six starts and \$65,144 in purses and could nearly triple her bankroll by winning the OHSS freshman trot and collecting \$150,000, sold the moderate brown filly at the Blooded Horse Sale in Springfield, OH. Howard and McClelland made the winning bid at \$95,000.

Why sell so close to the big race? Miller told sale company representatives that he was "only selling because we do not race in Ohio."

Miller does race in Ohio, at least he did part-time. Uncle Peters Love, to become eligible for Sunday's rich race, won twice at Scioto Downs in Columbus and once at Northfield. The three triumphs make her the top point earner in the Ohio Sires Stakes two-year-old filly trot division. She drew the No. 4 post position and is the 7-2 morning line betting choice in the seventh race on the 16-race program.

Virgil Morgan, one of Ohio's leading horsemen, is now training Uncle Peters Love for her new owners.

As for Miller, he may have felt that \$95,000 in his pocket is a safer bet than racing for \$150,000 with no guarantees.

Horses to watch in other Ohio Sires finales include Queen of the Pride in the 3-year-old filly pace (race No 12). She has

banked the most money (\$156,525) of any of the evening's participants. Lane of Stone, a 3-year-old male trotter, is the winningest horse on the card this year with eight victories in nine starts. He heads race No. 13.

The only undefeated horse racing is Elver Hanover, a two-year-old male pacer. He's five-for-five and is the 2-1 favorite in race No. 10.

Courtly Choice scores stunning upset in Canadian Pacing Derby

The 4-year-old Blake MacIntosh trainee, driven to victory by James MacDonald, scored at 30-1 against a top field of older pacers that included world record holder Lather Up and reigning U.S. and Canadian Horse of the Year McWicked.

Courtly Choice and driver James MacDonald stormed by rivals in the stretch for a 30-1 upset victory in Saturday's \$525,000 Canadian Pacing Derby at Woodbine Mohawk Park. The Blake MacIntosh trained 4-year-old rallied from sixth with a :25.3 final-quarter to nail heavy-favorite Lather Up at the wire for a 1:48.4 victory.

"It was amazing, I can't even put it into words I'm so happy," said MacDonald. "I've been trying to get a crack at one of these big ones in Canada and I just haven't had a lot of luck

and tonight the race set up great and the horse was just unbelievable."

Lather Up and driver Montrell Teague brushed from fourth to first entering the backstretch to overtake This Is The Plan, who cut a :25.4 opening-quarter. Courtly Choice and MacDonald got away seventh in the field and were following defending champion McWicked.

After a :54.1 half, Lather Up was confronted by first-up challenger Done Well heading to three-quarters. The racing action got tight going to three-quarters, as This Is The Plan was climbing over the back of Teague with Lather Up. The

1-5 favorite has previously had issues with turns and gave up a short-advantage to Done Well at three-quarters in 1:22.1.

Courtly Choice and MacDonald were set up to follow McWicked around the final-turn, but the defending champion moved back down to the rail. Courtly Choice ultimately was placed a couple lengths behind the second-over challenger Western Fame turning for home.

In the stretch, Lather Up embraced the straightaway and tried to pull away from rivals. Victory appeared to be within reach for Lather Up, until all eyes focused on Courtly Choice flying on the far outside, powering by rivals to reach up for a half-length victory.

Lather Up settled for second, while Western Fame was third and This Is The Plan finished fourth.

"I can't even explain the feeling, he was pacing so hard," said MacDonald of Courtly Choice. "I knew I had a lot of pace, but he was just trying to get into gear, and then everyone was kind of just fanning out and I didn't know what Lather Up would do because he always comes back on and he's just such a great horse."

"Lather Up has just been unbeatable, and just special to watch. Even just to be on the track is an honor and then to get to beat him in front of my home crowd... it was amazing."

A son of Art Major, Courtly Choice picks up his fourth win in 12 outings this season and 16th of his career. Last year's Little Brown Jug champion has now earned over \$1.3 million for owners Hutt Racing Stable, Mac And Heim Stables, Daniel Plouffe and Touchstone Farms Inc.

The Canadian Pacing Derby victory is the first for driver MacDonald and trainer MacIntosh, who noted the victory ranks near the top for him personally.

"Right up there because winning at your home track and we were an underdog coming in," said MacIntosh, noting that Courtly Choice was starting to return to top form in recent weeks. "I knew that James was taking care of him there the last couple weeks, and he looked like he was back to his old self, (I'm) just ecstatic about this."

Courtly Choice paid \$71.30, \$9.20, \$4.60. The \$2 Exacta with Lather Up returned \$205.90, while the \$2 Trifecta with Western Fame paid \$1,946.20. The Superfecta completed by This Is The Plan paid \$6,524.75 for a \$1 ticket.

The son of Archangel equals the 1:50.4 Canadian record in the process.

Guardian Angel As continued his dream season with a Canadian record equaling victory in Saturday's \$600,000 Maple Leaf Trot at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The Anette Lorentzon trained 5-year-old son of Archangel out of Provide As was moved to the top in the second quarter by driver Tim Tetrick and never looked back to win by half a length in 1:50.4.

"I got away in a real good spot there early, and then I had to make a decision," said Tetrick. "I thought my horse was the best tonight, I really did off last week's performance and he proved that he was."

The betting public couldn't separate elimination winners Guardian Angel As and Crystal Fashion, sending the trotters

off as co-favorites at 9-5.

The opening-quarter action saw mares Manchego and Emoticon Hanover blast from the outside towards the lead. Manchego held top spot through an opening-panel of :26.4 before Guardian Angel As leaped from third to first and led by the half in :55.

Crystal Fashion was angled out from fourth at the half and trotted first-up to the leader's wheel on the far turn. Despite never seeing the rail after starting from post-10, World champion Atlanta was situated second-over by driver Yannick Gingras and set to deliver another gritty performance.

After a three-quarter clocking of 1:23, Guardian Angel As led the field into the lane and attempted to create separation on his rivals. Atlanta tipped off cover and did all she could to track down the leader. Fans roared as the trotters stormed home with Guardian Angel As recreating last week's elimination victory over Atlanta by refusing to budge for a track, stakes and Canadian record equaling time of 1:50.4.

Guardian Angel As, who earlier this season set a world record on a half-mile track, held off Atlanta in last Saturday's elimination by three-quarters of a length.

"When he's on the front he relaxes a lot and then when he sees one coming, he keeps going," said Tetrick. "I can let him relax up there and when he sees one, he fights off and wants to go, so I was very confident."

Triple-millionaire Marion Marauder spent most of the mile on the outside and rallied from fourth-over to finish third. Crystal Fashion crossed the line fourth.

Guardian Angel As has led the older trotting division this season



and now sports stunning numbers of seven wins and \$699,434 earned in 10 starts. The Maple Leaf Trot victory pushes the now 23-time winner over \$1 million in career earnings for breeder/co-owner Acl Stuteri Ab and co-owner Kjell Johansson.

Trainer Lorentzon becomes just the second female trainer to win the Maple Leaf Trot, joining Hall of Famer Linda Toscano (2013, Market Share).

Guardian Angel As returned \$5.80, \$3.00, \$2.60. A \$2 Exacta with Atlanta paid \$28, while the \$2 Trifecta including Marion Marauder returned \$128.40. The Superfecta, completed by Crystal Fashion, paid \$146 for a \$1 winning ticket.

Triple Crown second leg, times two at Yonkers

Gimpanzee takes Yonkers Trot; American Mercury hot in Messenger final.

The second legs of the pacing and trotting Triple Crowns highlighted Yonkers Raceway's 12-race Saturday night. New York Sires Stake performers brought their best to both Grand Circuit stakes for 3-year-olds.

The \$500,000 Yonkers Trot final attracted a field of eight colts and geldings; no eliminations were required. Forbidden Trade was supplemented to the event when trainer Luc Blais and owner Serge Godin (Determination) of Montreal, QC observed how well the colt emerged from his Hambletonian victory and a subsequent (Aug. 12) Ontario Sires Stake (OSS) Gold win at Woodbine Mohawk Park. "It wasn't in our original plan, but plans change," said Blais in a Yonkers media release after last Monday's draw. "We let him tell us what to do and he's been training so well." Forbidden Trade landed post #6 for his Yonkers debut, with regular reinsman Bob McClure slated to drive him in the second leg of the trotting Triple Crown. He accumulated 13 wins over 20 career starts leading up to Yonkers' August 31 co-feature.

New York



Gimpanzee, from post #4, posed the most formidable opposition to Forbidden Trade. Owned by Courant Inc. of Delray Beach, FL and S R F Stable of Lighthouse Point, FL, the Marcus Melander-trained colt entered the Yonkers Trot undefeated in all but two of his 15 lifetime starts — he was fourth in his Hambletonian elim and finished third in the final. A 1:55.1h NYSS romp at Batavia Downs on Aug. 24 cemented Gimpanzee's credentials; his win margin was a decisive four-and-three-quarter lengths—not atypical among the Chapter Seven son's 13 career wins.

The half-mile specialist was favored over the Hambletonian champ, perhaps on account of Forbidden Trade's last start on a half: He was second to Only For Justice, three lengths back and timed in 1:57.1, in a May 19 OSS Gold event at Flamboro Downs.

In the Yonkers Trot final, longshot #3 Sheenas Boy (Andy Miller) took charge early, with #1 Osterc (George Brennan) jumping it off in second and being taken inside the pylons

on the first turn. Taking no chances, Brian Sears sent Gimpanzee to the front with ease, establishing a length-and-a-half lead over Sheenas Boy by the 28 flat opening quarter. Demonstrating trademark cornering prowess, the 1-5 betting favourite stayed perfect as #2 Soul Strong (Dexter Dunn) went offstride in pursuit on the second turn. That left Gimpanzee leading by three open lengths over Sheenas Boy at the 56.4 half, which is when the Hambletonian champ came calling first over from fourth.

There would be no faceoff between Sears' colt and McClure's. Gimpanzee just kept adding lengths to his lead as the wire drew nearer, while Forbidden Trade (3, 1:51.0m; \$1,032,728) had to circle a backpedalling Sheenas Boy around the 1:25 three-quarters, gaining but never getting within striking distance of Sears' horse in the stretch. He closing gamely for second, Forbidden Trade was denied the Triple Crown's second leg but joined the millionaires' club, four-and-a-half lengths behind Gimpanzee. Soul Strong rebounded for third, six lengths back of the winner. Sheenas Boy finished fourth, but was set back to sixth for a breaking rule violation in the stretch; #8 No Drama Please (Jason Bartlett) was moved up to fourth via placing after an inquiry.


Matching the host venue's 1:53.3h record for the Yonkers Trot (Windsongs Legacy won it in 1:53.1f at Hawthorne Racetrack in 2005), Gimpanzee (3, 1:52.4f; \$1,145,996) proved flawless in the 65th edition. He went over the million-dollar career earnings mark with the victory, in which he rewrote the Yonkers divisional track record. Regular driver Sears praised the Dan Patch Two-Year-Old Trotting Colt of the Year and his team in the winner's circle.

"The horse has done everything we asked all along. He's just a pleasure to drive. He makes my job very easy. He was really on his toes tonight," Sears told track publicity director Frank Drucker. "He was a perfect gentleman from day one and he continues to be that."

Trainer Marcus Melander, Dan Patch Rising Star for 2018, said taking it relatively easy with Gimpanzee at age 2 has

paid off handsomely. The divisional NYSS freshman champion colt "finished up in the Breeders Crown and we gave him some time off," explained his conditioner post-race. "Today, he's beaten some very good horses in here and he did it very easy." On that remarkable cornering ability: "He just lays down on the turns like a motorcycle. He's just an amazing horse. I don't think there's a better three-year-old on a half-mile than he is, and he showed it tonight."

Gimpanzee – originally named Army of Monkeys – was a \$170,000 yearling acquired at the 2017 Harrisburg sale. His dam, Steamy Windows, produced one previous foal, unraced Credit Winner filly Danish Girl, who sold for \$40,000 at Harrisburg in 2016. Owned by Stefan Balazsi's Order By Stables (Dan Patch 2018 Breeder of the Year), Muscle

Massive daughter Steamy Windows never took a mark on the track, but is working on making her mark as a broodmare: her latest yearling and third foal, Keep Your Coins, is a full sister to Gimpanzee.

American Mercury upsets at 7-1

The Messenger Stake final had a different complexion, as heavily-favored Bettors Wish drew post position #1 in a race without his closest divisional rival, Cane Pace/North America Cup title-holder Captain Crunch. Bettors Wish (Dexter Dunn) captured his non-wagering stake elim on August 24, going gate to wire in 1:53.1h. The second elimination went to the Linda Schadel-co-owned/trained Aflame Hanover (Corey Callahan), who wired rivals on that occasion in 1:52 flat. There was no show wagering offered in the final.

In the \$500,000 Messenger final, #3 American Mercury (Tyler Buter) left hard, but #1 Bettors Wish quickly charged to the front followed by #2 Branquinho (Ray Schnittker). With a gap of three lengths back to fourth-place #4 U S Captain (Jason Bartlett) at the 27 flat first quarter, the 1-9 favourite remained in command through a 55.3 half, although Bartlett's horse was on the attack first over and continued to fight Bettors Wish through the 1:23.3 three-quarters. U S Captain wasn't fully subdued turning for home, and Dunn's colt now faced additional pressure: Tyler Buter and American Mercury navigated a narrow path between the favourite and the pylons, lunging ahead of Bettors Wish by a head at the wire. U S Captain held third, a length back, in the 1:51.3 mile.

A 7-1 victor in the 64th Messenger final, American Mercury (p, 3, 1:49.4s; \$508,463) improved upon his place finish to Bettors Wish in their Messenger elimination. He was previously scratched sick from the Aug. 10 Milstein Invitational at Northfield Park. A smiling Tyler Buter expressed gratitude post-race: "(American Mercury) was super-sharp coming into the race. First and foremost, I owe (trainer) Chris (Oakes) a big thank you for giving me a shot on this horse. It's been a fun ride all summer, driving him and travelling New York. He definitely came through tonight and showed everybody on the big stage what he can do."

Buter explained the quick thinking behind his stretch drive: "I (came) off Dexter's helmet there and he kicked on the gas – I think that might have been the winning move, because if I stayed there, Dexter was probably going to back into me as much as he could. So then, as soon as I [came] off his helmet, Dexter stepped on the gas, and I was able to get back down the inside and find a little room late, and it worked out."


Trainer Chris Oakes said the lightly-raced 2-year-old has come back strong at age three, rewarding co-owners

Crawford Farms Racing, New York; Northfork Racing Stable, Pennsylvania; Chris Pompey, Pennsylvania; and Scott Bice, Ontario. American Mercury was bred by Steve Stewart, Julie Nash and Charlie Nash, all of Kentucky. The gelding is a son of American Ideal, out of the Somebeachsomewhere mare Tessa Hanover, an unraced daughter of prolific Triplet Hanover (p, 3, 1:52.1s; \$207,482). He brought \$170,000 as a yearling at the 2017 Lexington Select Sale. Tessa Hanover has a 2019 yearling colt, Ice House, sired by Always B Miki.

The moment when American Mercury started to get hot, in the most favourable sense of the expression? "When I gelded him!" said Oakes with a laugh. "He was kind of a big, growthy 2-year-old. He had a lot of ability; we loved him training down, and quite honestly wasn't quite as good as I thought he would be at 2, even though he raced some pretty good miles. Bringing him back at three, he was training good, but I just thought he'd probably be more focused, mentally, for racing, as a gelding. We made that decision and I honestly believe it helped him a lot—he means business now." The conditioner indicated the Messenger winner would now be pointed toward the Little Brown Jug.

Quincy Blue Chip in the Hudson

Corresponding distaff finals were also part of the Saturday night card. In the \$124,334 Hudson Filly Trot, 4-5 favourite

#5 Quincy Blue Chip (Jim Morrill Jr.) took charge after the 28.2 opening quarter, maintaining distance between herself and the rest to the 58 flat half, after pocket-sitter #4 Starita (Dexter Dunn) broke on the second turn. #3 Golden Tricks (Andy Miller) devoured Quincy Blue Chip's lead down the stretch, angling out of second at the 1:27.3 three-quarters to take down the leader in a win photo. Starita rallied for the show spot in the 1:56 flat mile. #1 Jezzy's Legacy broke leaving and was a non-factor.

"The trip couldn't have worked out any better," said Miller, who picked up the catch drive from trainer/usual driver Ake Svanstedt after Golden Tricks' break last week in her Zweig division at Vernon Downs. "I had more confidence when they told me she warmed up good." Bettors sent her off with less confidence; she was 7-1 in the Hudson. The Trixton daughter is the latest offspring of SJs Photo mare Golden Goose (3, 1:59.3m; \$2,080) to pass through the sales ring, bringing \$24,000 at Harrisburg in 2017. Golden Tricks (3, 1:52.2m; \$177,940) is owned by Brixton Medical Inc. of Matawan, New Jersey.

Trillions Hanover wins Lady Maud

The \$122,224 Lady Maud field consisted of five fillies, after the scratch of #6 Annie Hill. #4 Trillions Hanover (George

Brennan) was on the move first over from last approaching the half, while #5 Bestseller Hanover (Jason Bartlett) set the early fractions of 27.3 and 57.1. That pair duelled as the pace picked up to the 1:24.4 three-quarters, with announcer John Hernan declaring, "It's pretty much wide open here." #1 Jk American Beauty (Jordan Stratton) was able to find room between the battling leaders as the finish loomed; #3 Blue Ivy (Tyler Buter) closed well, widest of all. In the end, it was Tom Fanning trainee Trillions Hanover (3, 1:50.0m; \$130,968) who won the sprint down the stretch, edging out Jk American Beauty (second) and Bestseller Hanover (third) in 1:53.1.

A Somebeachsomewhere daughter of Tutu Hanover (p, 3, 1:52.0s; \$117,687), the 2019 Lady Maud winner was originally named Thompson Hanover. Trillions Hanover (p, 3, 1:50.0m; \$192,080) is owned by VIP Internet Stable of Piscataway, New Jersey; Falcon Racing LLC of Jackson, New Jersey; and Paul R Lang of Paramus, New Jersey. Tutu Hanover is a daughter of 2019 Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame inductee Tricky Tooshie.

Colours of The Great Ourasi wins \$220,400 Criterium des 5 ans

Vincennes racetrack in Paris offered a race card with large purses on Saturday afternoon and the \$220,400 Criterium des 5 ans attracted 16 trotters around the big track and a hefty 1.9 miles was the distance.

After a perfect cover trip behind leader Earl Simon, Eric Raffin found his space to let Eugenito du Noyer (Saxo de Vandel) sprint home the victory ahead of first choice and quick finisher Enino du Pommereux.

Eric Raffin, dressed in the blue and yellow colours of Ourasi (Ecurie Ostheimer), who won this particular race himself in 1985 for trainer Jean-Rene Gougeon, collected his second victory in Criterium des 5 ans.

In 2014, Raffin won with Vabellino who was the first winner in the race for trainer Sébastien Guarato. Guarato took the trophy in 2016 and 2017 with Bold Eagle and Carat Williams.

Eugenito du Noyer is trained by Jean-Michel Baudouin and the mile rate over 1.9 miles was a splendid 1:56.1. Runner up Enino du Pommereux came home just a head behind the winner in same mile rate and Epic Julry finished very strongly from a bad position for show.

World record by Face Time Bourbon

Sébastien Guarato's 4-year-old Face Time Bourbon (Ready Cash) impressed a lot when he won the \$110,200 Prix Jules

Thibault for 4-year-old colts at Vincennes. Björn Goop sent the son of Ready Cash to the front and the pace was high since first over trotting Fakir du Lorault made sure that the leader wouldn't make the game too simple. Goop tried to leave his opponents in the last turn and Face Time Bourbon got a couple of lengths ahead at the home stretch. Pretty easily Face Time Bourbon got the victory in a great mile rate of 1:54.3 over 1.6 miles, which is a world record mark over the actual distance.

Guarato also collected the trophy in the \$110,200 Prix Guy le Gonidec for 4-year-old mares. Jean Philippe Monclin steered Saxo de Vandel mare Fleche Bourbon to victory in mile rate 1:57.4 over 1.6 miles.

Philippe Allaire trained Gotland was the first choice in the \$110,200 Prix Victor Regis for 3-year-old colts and it all looked safe during the race when Gotland was sent to the lead at an early stage. But first over trotter Good Boy Lignerries (Un Mec d'Heripre) and Franck Nivard didn't surrender on the outside and shortly before the wire, the Philippe Billard trained Good Boy Lignerries had his head first. The mile rate was 1:56.3 over 1.3 miles.

Raffin and Guarato would also celebrate together at Vincennes on the afternoon. In \$110,400 Prix Uranie for 3-year-old mares, Raffin sat behind Guarato's Gunilla d'Atout (Ready Cash) and after a quick start where Eric Raffin put his horse in front, the duo gave the lead over to Jean-Michel Bazire and Galilea Money midway through the race.

Gunilla d'Atout got space to sprint in the home stretch and she easily disarmed first choice Green Grass, who had traveled on the outside of the leader the last kilometer.

Graceful Swamp in Finnish Derby

The \$330,600 Finnish Derby for 4-year-olds were held at Verno racetrack in Helsinki, Finland on Saturday afternoon and in his 34th start, Erkki Pekka Mäkinen's Graceful Swamp (So Perfect) noted his 28th win when he led most of the Derby for driver Ari Moilanen.

The duo hit the lead in the first turn in the 1.6-mile long race and when the chasers behind tried to challenge

Graceful Swamp for real in the stretch, he fought stronger and won in a mile rate of 1:57.4 that equaled the stakes record.

The runner up was Knows Nothing son Knows Best and third was Peanuts (Andover Hall).

In the \$66,000 Finnish Championship, quick starter Next Direction (Orlando Vici) led all the way paired with Iikka Nurmonen. First over trotter Atupem, who upset in \$154,000 Seinäjoki Race in April, tried to disarm the leader but never got close enough at the stretch and Next Direction came home in stakes record 1:54.1 over 1.3 miles.

Record at Kolgjini sale on Friday night

Swedish top trainer, breeder and harness racing business entrepreneur Lutfi Kolgjini arranged his yearling sale at his farm in Vomb, south of Sweden on Friday night and when the night was over, a European record was broken.

Last year, at the French Arqana Trot sales in Deauville, Hunter Valley was sold for 400,000 euro, approximately \$440,800 and during Kolgjini's sale on Friday night, Chapter Seven colt Aristoteles Face (out of Just Not Into You) fetched 4,700,000 Swedish crowns, \$479,000, a new European record for a yearling sold at auction.

Just Not Into You was purchased at the Harrisburg mixed sale for \$35,000 in 2017.

Gambling on harness races is probably your game of choice. Each wager is an attempt to solve the riddle of a race using the clues. We make our choices and back them with our money. In a very short time, we learn the answer and then face another challenge in the next race.

Purchasing a yearling out of a big fat catalog is also a challenge. In about 10 months we learn just how smart we were when we raised our hand and opened our checkbook.

Want to win big by solving a harness racing challenge?

Soon, another contest will appear in this little corner of the universe. You may want to play. You will not need to compose a sentence or write a poem. Your task will be to solve a riddle that will lead you to a single page in the Lexington Yearling Sales Catalogue.

The challenge will be difficult. Some potential winners will find mere satisfaction in a quest that leads to a successful conclusion. For the more mercenary among you, money will be on the line, serious money for a frivolous contest involving harness racing yearling that will soon be on the auction block.

Entering contests can have therapeutic benefits.

For example, imagine that your problem solving in harness racing did not go well and the riddles of the races were not solved. Perhaps the puzzle of paying your latest training bill with insufficient revenues looms.

You are in need of a chuckle. At this point I suggest you turn to another contest, a writing contest that I am yet to win, but each visit makes me laugh.

In the writing game, first sentences are important. If the reader does not finish

the first sentence, often, they will not read the second sentence. To put this in racing terms, a poor first sentence is like breaking behind the starting gate. It is very difficult to recover from. Some first sentences in literature are remarkable and they remain etched into our mind -

"All happy families are alike; each unhappy family is unhappy in its own way." (*Anna Karenina* by **Leo Tolstoy**).

"We were somewhere around Barstow on the edge of the desert when the drugs began to take hold." (*Fear and Loathing in Las Vegas* by **Hunter S. Thompson**).

"You don't know about me without you have read a book by the name of The Adventures of Tom Sawyer, but that ain't no matter ." (*Adventures of Huckleberry Finn* by **Mark Twain**).

On the other hand, some first sentences are not remarkable. They are wretched. Literary tastes vary, but among the poster children for a bad opening sentence, you will find a novel, Paul Clifford, published in 1830 by **Edward Bulwer-Lytton** .

"It was a dark and stormy night; the rain fell in torrents - except at occasional intervals, when it was checked by a violent gust of wind which swept up the streets (for it is in London that our scene lies) rattling along the housetops, and fiercely agitating the scanty flame of the lamps that struggled against the darkness ."

This disjointed and rambling first sentence evolved into the **Bulwer-Lytton Fiction Contest (BLFC)**. The annual contest began in 1982 sponsored by the English Department of **San Jose State University**. It challenges entrants to compose a truly terrible **opening sentence and send it in for judging**. Winners in a variety of literary genres receive fine awards. Three recent BLFC winners:

"On their first date he'd asked how much she thought Edgar Allan Poe's toe nails would sell for on eBay and on their second he paid for subway fair with nickels he fished out of a fountain, but he was otherwise charming and she thought that they could have a perfectly tolerable life together." **Jessica Sasishara**

"As the sun dropped below the horizon, the safari guide confirmed the approaching cape buffaloes were herbivores, which calmed everyone in the group, except for Herb, of course ." **Ron D. Smith**

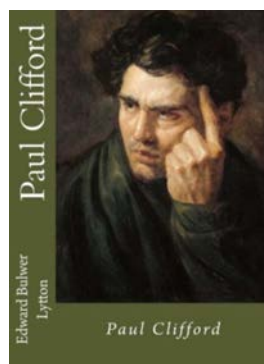

Alicorn dazzles with second OSS record of 2019

On Friday evening (Aug. 30) 2-year-old pacing filly **Alicorn** rewrote the Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) history books for the second time this summer, rocketing around Woodbine Mohawk Park in 1:50.3 for her second Gold Series victory.

Starting from Post 3, regular reinsman Louis-Philippe Roy eased the heavy favorite away from the gate and settled in fourth as Kat took the field of nine to a :27.1 opening quarter. Karma Seelster quickly took control of the lead, but Alicorn was hot on her heels and had taken control by the :55.1 half. Once they had control, Alicorn and Roy stepped up the tempo and powered through a 1:22.4 three-quarters on their way to the 1:50.3 victory. Karma Seelster and Kat finished second and third, two and one-quarter lengths behind the winner.

“She’s just a big beast in a small body,” said Guelph, ON resident Roy. “I was a little concerned with the way I had to use her to get to the front at the half, but when I pulled the plugs down the lane she let me know it was game over.”

“I was glad to see her get away fourth. Even though she only sat in until just about the quarter pole and then he removed her, I was glad to see her do that. I didn’t want to see her get too aggressive behind the gate, because she can take a good hold of you behind the gate,” said trainer Chantal Mitchell. “She’s always been like that, she knows what she’s there to do when she gets in behind the starting car, but when she makes the front she kind of goes to sleep. So it’s a Catch-22 with how you want to race a horse like her really, but every time you ask her she gives you more.”

The mile lowered the filly’s own Ontario Sires Stakes record by two-fifths of a second. She won her July 19 Gold Series start at Woodbine Mohawk Park in 1:51.

Friday’s victory was Alicorn’s second straight at Woodbine Mohawk Park, she captured her Eternal Camnation division last weekend, and her fourth of the season. In seven starts the Bettors Delight daughter has banked \$216,889 for owners Windermere Stable LLC of New York, NY and Robert

Muscara of Ivyland, PA.

“I feel like she’s getting stronger and stronger. She’s feeling better and better after every start,” said Mitchell. “When she gets to the racetrack she just knows how to turn it on, because at home she’s a nice quiet little filly and when she gets to the track she’s got her game face on.”

The 2-year-old pacing fillies will wrap up their Gold Series regular season at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Sept. 30, but before that Alicorn is also eligible to the Champlain Pace on Sept. 7 and the Shes A Great Lady, which sees eliminations on Sept. 14 and the final on Sept. 21.

“We’ll just see how she comes out of it (Friday’s race), because it’s a pretty tight schedule from here on to the end of the year,” said Mitchell about whether the filly will race in both the Champlain and Shes A Great Lady. “If she were to race in every race she’s got, she’d only be getting one week off between now and the end of the Breeders Crown.”

The other \$107,200 Gold Series division went to Temagami Seelster and driver Yannick Gingras, who used a similar strategy from Post 5. The fan favorites got away third, watching P L Notorious roll out to a :26.4 opening quarter, and then followed Rose Run Vantage up the outside, overtaking that filly heading by the :55.1 half. Temagami Seelster led the field to a 1:23.4 three-quarters and when Rose Run Vantage and Peak Sneaky tried to reel her in down the stretch the filly dug in and held on for a head victory in 1:52. Rose Run Vantage and Peak Sneaky had to settle for second and third.

“About halfway down the lane it looked like they were going by her on the inside and the outside, and then he kicked the plugs and she dug right back in,” said trainer Wayne McGean. “She’s got a heart, that’s for sure.”

The win was Temagami Seelster’s first in Gold Series action. In the first three Gold legs the Sunshine Beach daughter finished second twice and third once. In nine starts, the filly has only missed the top three on two occasions, earning \$144,913 for McGean, who hails from Sydney Mines, NS and his partners David Mercer and Joseph Lewis of Sydney, NS.

“She was riding under the radar,” said the trainer. “This evening I told Yannick she’s a nice filly. He said, ‘Yeah, you drew away from some of the tougher ones’, and I said, ‘Yeah, but I think she’s a tough one too. I think she’s a real nice filly.’ He said, ‘Okay’. And he drove her like she was the best.”

“She knows what it’s all about now I think. She kind of proved tonight that she knows what it’s all about. She was beat halfway down the lane, you know that and I know that right, but once he pulled the plugs then she dug back in.”

Like Alicorn, Temagami Seelster is eligible to the Champlain and Shes A Great Lady stakes and McGean is also taking a wait and see approach. Both fillies are currently

among the top five point earners in the Gold Series division and will be assured of a berth in the Oct. 12 Super Final at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Synergy by a nose in Champlain

Father Patrick colt **Synergy** got up the rail to win by the narrowest of margins in Friday's \$182,876 Champlain Stakes for 2-year-old trotters at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

A full field of 10 rookies met up for the Grand Circuit contest. Per Engblom trainee Synergy went off as the slight favorite over Luc Blais' Port Perry and the two rookies would be connected throughout.

Synergy and driver Yannick Gingras moved up to the top from second moving into the backstretch. Port Perry and driver Bob McClure followed and zipped up to lead the field by the half in :57.2. Horse Trader applied first-up pressure going to three-quarters, sitting a length away from Port Perry in 1:26.4.

Port Perry put away the outside rival in the stretch, but drifted off the rail just enough that Synergy could shoot through in deep stretch. The rookies hit the line in a photo finish that saw Synergy reach up to win by a nose in 1:55.4. Horse Trader finished third, while Scamp and Nylander finished in a dead-heat for fourth.

"I wasn't sure honestly, it was really tight," said Gingras of the photo finish. "I had the momentum going across, so I knew I had a chance, but it was too close to call.

"When Bobby (McClure) came I was happy to let him go. My horse is really good, but he hadn't raced in a month and he's been on the front a few times, so I was definitely happy to follow somebody."

Synergy was making his first start since finishing fifth in the Peter Haughton Memorial on Aug. 3 at The Meadowlands. The Engblom trainee has now won three of four starts and earned \$121,854 for owners Brittany Farms, John Fielding, Herb Liverman and David Anderson. He was a \$275,000 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale purchase.

A \$2 win ticket on Synergy returned \$5.20.

Friday evening's program also saw a jaw-dropping performance from **Youaremycandygirl** in the \$30,000 mares preferred. The four-year-old mare was making her debut for trainer Richard Moreau and made an immediate statement.

Driver Louis Philippe Roy angled Youaremycandygirl out from third approaching three-quarters and immediately surged up alongside Seaswift Joy N, who reached the third marker in 1:23.3.

Youaremycandygirl was in full flight swinging into the lane and stormed away from her rivals with an incredible :25.3

final-quarter to win in 1:49.1.

Owned by W Donovan, Youaremycandygirl picked up her second win in 10 starts this season. The career-earners of \$1.5 million now has 20 career victories. She paid \$19.20 to win.

Repeat winners in Indiana Sires Stakes action at Hoosier

Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino played host to a stakes filled card on Friday (Aug. 30) as the Indiana Sires Stakes season pressed on with two \$50,500 divisions of Indiana Sires Stakes action for 3-year-old pacing colts and geldings and two \$68,000 divisions for the 2-year-old pacing colts and geldings highlighting the evening's 13-race card. Familiar faces found the winner's circle and it was a good night for favorites as all of last week's divisional round winners repeated in their respective divisions and three of the four winners delivered as the heavy betting favorite.

In the opening division of the stakes action, **Rockie Got Framed** turned in another gritty performance to record back to back stakes wins in the 3-year-old pacing colt division in 1:49.3. With regular pilot Ricky Macomber Jr. in the sulky, Rockie Got Framed moved first-over around the final turn and used a :26.2 to hold off the post time-favorite, Shamwow and LeWayne Miller, and get the win by a head. The pace-setting Tellmeaboutit and Mike Oosting held on for third. Sent off as the public's second choice at 2-1, Rockie Got Framed returned \$6.20 to his backers at the betting windows.

"The trip didn't work out at all like I thought it would," Macomber Jr. said. "The last few starts though, he's showed that he loves to fight horses off. We made a few equipment changes in the last few starts and he's really turning into a tough race horse. He loves to fight them off."

With the win, Rockie Got Framed posted his fifth win from his last six starts and eighth victory from 16 starts this season. Owned in partnership by Rocco Ruffolo and Eleven Star Stable, the gelded son Rockin Image—Carousel upped his lifetime bankroll to \$166,606. The 1:49.3 clocking equaled the lifetime best the Jamie Macomber trainee established against stakes company last week. Rockie Got Framed was bred by Hanover Shoe Farms.

Odds On Osiris kicked off the stakes action for the 2-year-old competitors and won with authority as he stamped himself as one of the top freshman colts in the Hoosier state. With driver Peter Wrenn in the sulky, Odds On Osiris turned a pocket trip into a 1:51.4 victory and made

good on his 1-5 post time odds. Employing a :26.2 final panel, the Melanie Wrenn trainee finished two lengths in front of Always And Again and Trace Tetrack to record his third straight victory. Stellar BB and Robert Taylor utilized a ground-saving trip to get up for third. Odds On Osiris returned \$2.60 to his backers at the betting windows.

"He's really coming into himself," Wrenn said. "He's starting to get really handy. You never know with these young colts going these big miles week in and week out but as long as he keeps coming back with these type of miles, that's what you want."

Odds On Osiris, the 2019 Fox Stake Champion, has now won three of five starts this season as he pushed his lifetime earnings to \$89,365. The gelded son of Rockin Image—Antigua Hanover is owned by Odds On Racing and was bred by Merlie Schwartz.

Little Rocket Man looked every bit the part of a 6-5 favorite as he used a gate to wire effort to capture his split of the Indiana Stakes action for 3-year-old pacing colts and geldings and stop the timer in 1:49.1. Driver Trace Tetrack sent Little Rocket Man away from the gate firing and dictated the pace before fighting off a late surge from White Hair Rocks and John DeLong to get the win by a head. Pure Rock and Rick Plano utilized a pocket-trip to round out the trifecta. Little Rocket Man returned \$4.40 at the betting windows.

"Well, I didn't necessarily want to be on the front," Tetrack said after the win. "That's the way the race worked out and it ended up working out for us. He did all the work. He raced super again, he shows up every week."

Trained by Melissa Essig, Little Rocket Man recorded his second straight stakes win and 10th victory from 13 lifetime outings. The gelded son of Rockin Image—Gt Miss Royal is owned by Russell Beeman and Jack Freeman and pushed his lifetime bankroll to \$125,380 with the win. Unraced as a 2-year-old, Little Rocket Man was bred by Victory Hill Farm.

Clever Character used similar front-running tactics to capture the final split of the stakes action for 2-year-old pacing colts and geldings in dominating fashion for driver Dale Hiteman. Stopping the timer in 1:52, Clever Character left alertly from post six to grab the lead just before the half and never looked back.

Kicking home in :26.4, the Timothy Smith trainee held off a fast closing Sawyer's Desire and Ricky Macomber Jr. to get the win by nearly two lengths and establish a new lifetime best in the process. Sawyer's Desire was forced to settle for second while High Impression and Sam Widger used a pocket trip to finish third. As the 3-5 post time favorite, Clever Character returned \$3.40 at the betting windows.

"He's the type of horse that makes you look good no matter how you drive him," Hiteman said. "He's got extreme speed

and, knock on wood, has been healthy all season."

With the win, the gelded son of Tellitlikeitis—Ruby Delight posted his second consecutive stakes victory and fourth trip to the winner's circle in six starts this season. Owned and trained by Timothy Smith, Clever Character now sports a lifetime bankroll of \$95,375 and was bred by Freedom Hill Farms.

Friday's stakes action wrapped up a week's worth of Indiana Sires Stakes action at Hoosier Park. The 2-year-old competitors have now completed round four of their six round series while the sophomore division has completed round six of their eight round series. All of the evening's divisional winners earned valuable points for the season-culminating \$250,000 Indiana Sires Stakes Super Finals slated for Oct. 11 at Harrah's Hoosier Park.

The pre-card quintet was led by **Hickfromfrenchlick** (Matt Kakaley), disposing of his four inside rivals in 1:52.4. Taking over from Major Blake (Jason Bartlett), Hickfromfrenchlick threw down intervals of :27.1, :56.1 and 1:24.4 before the final maker.

He defeated a misbehaved-early Artie's Ideal (Marcus Miller) by a half-length, with Major Blake third. Respect Our Flag (Joe Bongiorno) and Bicorné Hanover (George Brennan) were the stragglers.

For Hickfromfrenchlick, a son of So Surreal co-owned by (trainer) Ray Schnittker, NolaMaura Racing and Thomas Spatarico, it was his seventh wins (with two seconds and a third) in 10 seasonal starts (\$275,886). Last season's Sheppard winner here is now 11-for-17 lifetime,

"Use whatever word you want about him," Kakaley said. "Fast, gusty, handy."

Pole-sitting **Rollwithpapajoe** (Bongiorno, \$5.80) finished what he started (:28., :57.4, 1:25.1, 1:53) a few races later.

Covered Bridge (Brian Sears) chased from the pocket, missing a length-and-three-quarters, while 13-10 fave Major

March (Bartlett) was a two-move third. Dealer's Table (Jordan Stratton) and Melodie's Major (Tyler Buter) brought up the rear.

For 'Papajoe,' a Roll with Joe gelding co-owned by Barbara Bongiorno Stable, Bill Lambos & Dionisios Liberatos and trained by Jennifer Bongiorno, it was his fifth win in 15 '19 starts. The exacta paid \$13, with neither triple nor superfecta wagering offered.

"He has such quick speed that he can put himself in good spots," driver Bonorno said.

If the sire stakes results were quite predictable, they weren't nearly the 'free space' of It's Rigged (Buter). That one had things—and the oval—all to himself, walking over a bottom-level state-bred Excelsior event in 1:56.4.

SBOANJ announces distribution of NJ state appropriation sired bonus awards

The Standardbred Breeders and Owners Association of New Jersey (SBOANJ) will administer the distribution of New Jersey Sired bonus money which will be paid out on a monthly basis retroactive from April 1, 2019. These awards, the result of a \$10 million state appropriation, have also funded a breeder's awards program and increased purses for SBOANJ sponsored races.

The payouts for the New Jersey Sired awards will be distributed to 6-year-old and under sired horses who finish first through fifth. Payout is based on the average purse at each racetrack and distributed according to race placement. Only overnight races will receive bonus awards; series and stake races will be excluded. The bonus will be paid to the first owner of record and a W-9 form is required for distribution.

Along with the breeders awards and New Jersey sired bonus money, the SBOANJ will contribute over \$200,000 to SBOANJ sponsored races in order to further enhance the purses. Updated information on the final purses will be announced shortly.

In an effort to provide more racing opportunities as well as enhanced purses for owners of NJ-sired horses, the SBOANJ is sponsoring a late closing series at both Freehold and The Meadowlands for 3-year-old New Jersey bred trotters. There will be 2 legs with a purse of \$15,000 each and a \$50,000 final. A 4-year-old series will be offered next year.

The New Jersey sired pacers will be represented by a SBOANJ sponsored open pace on Open Space Pace Day at Freehold Raceway on Sept. 21 for a purse of \$20,000.

Priceless, Grace Rocks capture Indiana Sires Stakes at Hoosier

A pair of Indiana Sires Stakes divisions for 2-year-old pacing fillies were showcased at Harrah's Hoosier Park on Thursday (Aug. 29) and brought forth impressive performances from the freshman fillies. **Priceless** and **Grace Rocks** each won their respective \$69,500 divisions and did so with authority to deliver as the favorites.

After suffering the first loss of her young career in stakes action last week, Priceless rebounded gamely and was the fastest divisional winner with a 1:51.4 open length score. With driver, trainer Brandon Bates at the lines, Priceless converted a pocket trip into a three and half-length victory to establish a new lifetime best.

Leaving from post two in the competitive field of 11, Bates sent Priceless away from the gate and would win the early tussle for position to grab the lead in :26.4. John DeLong was offensive minded with Seventimesacharm and she would grab command just before the half in a snappy :54.3.

Seventimesacharm hit the third station in 1:23.4 and when the field turned for home, Trace Tetrack had the slight post time favorite Foxy Rigger applying pressure from first-over. With an undefeated streak on the line, Foxy Rigger appeared to be up to the task but Priceless was looming large in the pocket.

Utilizing the passing lane and a :27.3 final brush, Priceless powered home to finish in front of Foxy Rigger. Sombodyslilly and Mike Oosting got up for third place honors as one of the longest shots on the board. Sent off at odds of 9-5, Priceless returned \$5.80 to her backers at the betting windows.

"She scoped sick last week," Bates said. "We took care of that and scoped her yesterday and she was perfect. Tonight was the best trip she's had in a while; she loves to race off a helmet and loves to chase horses."

With the win, the daughter of Rockin Image—Btwnyurheartnmine recorded her fourth win from five lifetime outings. Priceless pushed her lifetime bankroll to \$88,662 for owners Kevin Miller and Bert Hochsprung.

In the second division of the stakes action, Grace Rocks continued her winning ways and turned in another dominant performance to score in 1:53.2. With Sam Widger in the sulky, Grace Rocks switched up her tactics and opted for a trip off the pace to deliver as the heavy 1-9 favorite.

Unhurried from the gate, Grace Rocks eased off the gate to find a spot along the rail in fifth while a host of others left aggressively. Bluebird Love and Todd Warren were the first to get a call through the opening quarter in :26.3 before yielding the lead to Flirtinwithtrouble and Brandon Bates just before the half in :55.2.

Kickin Up My Heels and Trace Tetrack were the first to commit to the outer flow and Widger quickly grabbed the cover with Grace Rocks. As the field reached the three-quarters in 1:24.3, Kickin Up My Heels was able to put away Flirtinwithtrouble and the rest of the field was also closing in quickly. Widger tipped Grace Rocks and the filly appeared to cruise to the wire with ease finishing two lengths in front of Kickin Up My Heels. Flirtinwithtrouble held on for third. Grace Rocks returned \$2.20 to her backers at the betting windows.

"She just does everything that she's asked," trainer Ronnie Roberts said of his filly. "She's a sweetheart. Not only is she a pleasure to train, but she's a pleasure to be around as well."

With the win, Grace recorded her fifth straight victory and third straight Indiana Sires Stakes victory. The daughter of Rockin Image-Cosmic Grace has five wins and one second from six starts this season. Owned by Howard Taylor, Grace Rocks now sports a lifetime bankroll of \$90,250.

R N Nate crossed six lengths in front of Scott Woogen's Pier Ho Temptation. Lima Illusion was third.

John's Dream finishing time of 1:56.4 established a track record in the first Jenkins division, though the mark lasted all of 15 minutes. Owner/trainer/driver Chuck Perry guided the winning effort against four others by wiring the field in fractions of :28.3, :59 and 1:28.2 and crossing 1 1/2 lengths the best.

The 102nd edition of County Fair races began Wednesday and through two cards now, Hammer has four wins followed by 23-year-old Sierra Graham who has three. Hammer's hat trick opening day included wins with Linda's Will, Blow Back and Jukebox Hero. Graham scored both Wednesday and today with Rock On Dock and again later in today's card with Milly B Gone. Racing continues Friday and Saturday with cards at 12 Noon.

A graduate of Deerfield Beach High School who racked up a cumulative 4.9 GPA taking rigorous coursework weighted toward math and science, Jonathan enrolled at the University of Central Florida in 2015. He is now a senior there and has continued to amass a laudable record (3.7 GPA) while pursuing a bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering, a minor in Computer Science and a Master's in Material Engineering. The BS to MS program, which adds master level courses in the junior and senior years, means that Jonathan will have just one additional year after attaining his undergraduate diploma – unless, as he put it in his essay, "I make the decision to strive forward with my PhD." His academic success already afforded him the opportunity to attain a job working as a researcher at UCF's College of Optics and Photonics, a world leader in the science of lasers, LED's, LCD's, optical fibers and imaging systems applied in industry and medicine. And despite the demanding schedule, Jonathan has been honored for his community service as a volunteer at animal shelters and Habitat for Humanity. "Harness racing has been a part of my life for as long as I can remember," wrote Hallett. "I have always loved [it]..." Since adolescence Jonathan has spent every summer based at Tioga Downs, traveling up and down the East Coast for stakes and overnights with the Hallett Racing Stable. Winters the family was back home in South Florida at their Pompano Park base. Parents John and Michelle and sister Jessica, a Snyder Memorial Scholarship recipient herself in 2017 and 2018, can be very proud of this exceptional young man.

SARAH BIRK HOLD, 25, Sarasota, FL, \$5,000

Currently in her third year of veterinary school at Lincoln Memorial University in Cumberland Gap, TN, Sarah last year became the first applicant since the scholarship program's

inception in 1973 to earn a top award three times. She has now done it again for the fourth consecutive year. Her academic chops remain impressive. She has maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.9 (all A's, two B's and one C in 31 different specialized courses), good enough to move her up one notch in class rank, 16th of 117. Besides attending conventions of the Florida and National Beef Cattlemen's Associations, as well as the Student American Veterinary Medical Association Conference, Sarah stays heavily involved in university organizations as an officer in the Society for Theriogenology (reproductive systems of animals) and the Food Animal Club, whose members share feeding shifts for 60 head of cattle and 20 horses at the school's farm. Ms. Birkhold's devotion to harness racing and her profession shines through numerous passages in her application essays, which she annually updates with fresh perspectives and new experiences: "Sadly, this is my last summer off from school before I start my life of clinical rotations and finally as a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine," she wrote. "I know I may not move back home once I graduate, so I have been sentimental. Every morning and evening I help my Dad take care of our 25-horse stable. We are currently breaking two yearlings, racing three horses and training a two-year-old colt. I bred one of our mares back...we are anticipating three foals next year! Reproduction and lameness initially sparked my interest because those topics were always a focus in our barn. The joy my Dad gets sharing his passion is what makes me the happiest. I feel so motivated to specialize in equine lameness because I want to share that same feeling of accomplishment my clients would feel overcoming a challenge with their horse."

KENT BEATTIE, 25, Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, \$2,500.

A former resident of Fredericton, NB, where his parents still reside, Kent was a 2015 Bachelor of Science Honors graduate of The University of New Brunswick who majored in Medicinal Chemistry and earned a 3.9 GPA. He is now a solid A-/B+ student completing his final year at Charlottetown's Atlantic Veterinary College, a 12-month clinical stint with no opportunity to earn income from summer employment. Kent is determined to continue his family's four-generation involvement with harness racing as a vet. Licensed to train at age 13, and drive at age 14, he has been active as a part-time groom, trainer and occasional driver, most recently at Red Shores Charlottetown Driving Park. His great-grandfather trained and drove full-time in the 1950's and '60's, his grandfather judged at Fredericton Raceway for many years, and both his uncle, who operated a public stable, and father, a director on the boards of the Fredericton Horsemen's Association and Horse Racing New Brunswick, trained and owned standardbreds. Kent does manage to engage in several mind-clearing downtime activities. "I played saxophone in the high school concert and jazz bands and

was on the basketball team," he stated. "Since beginning university I have had to give up competitive basketball, but I still enjoy playing my saxophone and shooting hoops in the gym." Future clients take note. Horses appreciate a relaxed vet.

SYDNEY TROTTO, 19, Springfield, VA, \$2,500

Sydney is now in her sophomore year at James Madison University in Harrisonburg, VA. Another repeat recipient of this scholarship, she has already earned 42 credit hours as a Bachelor of Science candidate majoring in Nursing with Chronic Illness as her minor. JMU has an extremely competitive nursing program ranked #1 in the state, and Sydney is flourishing there. She earned all A's and two A-'s (3.943 GPA) her freshmen year, resulting in two consecutive semesters on the 3.9 or above President's List. She is an active member of Gamma Phi Beta Sorority and the campus Intervarsity Christian Ministry. A compelling letter of recommendation from JMU Instructor Colleen Watson began with this assertion: "I had the pleasure of having Sydney in Elementary

Statistics...a notorious course because of its high unsuccessful rate [DFW, *drop, fail, withdrawal]. Sydney ended up absolutely excelling and finished third of 171 students. Top 3 is extraordinary." Ms. Watson continued: "I had a student with a disability that required a notetaker. I asked for volunteers, which often is a long process. Sydney immediately signed up, receiving no compensation in any form, and due to confidentiality, would never know who she was helping. A notetaker must attend EVERY class, take detailed and neat notes, and then upload them to the disability site. As a future nurse, she is already displaying the compassion and maturity that will help her succeed and thrive in her career. She exemplified work ethic, academic prowess and kindness, and this deserves to be rewarded beyond an A in my class." Ms. Trotto is the daughter of harness horse trainer Greg Trotto and his wife Debbie, a teacher in the Fairfax County Public Schools. The couple also has a son, Gregory, Jr., 20, who attends George Mason University in Virginia.

Crucial protected position from the pylons while Ms Savannah Belle ducked for the pocket heading to a :28.4 opening quarter. Bange Bi raced wide from third and progressed towards the pacesetter nearing a :57.1 half but failed to clear. Crucial kept Bange Bi parked past three-quarters in 1:26.2 before the first-over challenger dropped anchor and opened room for Ms Savannah Belle to pounce. Driver Jimmy Takter sent the Muscle Hill filly after Crucial at the head of the stretch and kicked clear to a four-and-three-quarter length victory over Heaven. Crucial held third.

A homebred for Al Libfeld, Ms Savannah Belle won her second race from five starts, earning \$54,658. Per Engblom trains the \$2.80 winner.

Driver Chris Page circled 3-2 favorite **Violet Stride** to the front past the quarter and held firm on the lead in progress to a 1:55.2 victory in the second KYSS filly split.

Page positioned the Trixton filly third behind early duelers Do You Wanna Dance and Julia C heading to a :28.3 first quarter. He then sent the Mark Harder trainee after Do You Wanna Dance and took control before a :57.4 half. From there she withstood minor first-over pressure from Julia C passing three-quarters in 1:27.1 while holding off that challenger by two-and-three-quarter lengths at the finish. Sequin rallied from a pylon trip for third.

Bred by Kentuckiana Farms LLC and Jorgen Jahre Jr., Violet Stride won her second race from six starts, earning \$34,250. Emilio & Maria Rosati own the \$5.00 winner.

Page also steered **Cover Girl** to a 1:56.3 victory in the final filly division of KYSS.

Even-money favorite Caviart Eva cleared the front moving to a :29.3 opening quarter while Page had Cover Girl placed fourth. He soon pulled the Paul Kelley trainee first over past a :59 half and rushed to the helm circling the final turn. Cover Girl led Caviart Eva passed three-quarters in 1:28.2 and strode clear to a two-and-a-half length victory. Miss Kendra D, off a pylon trip, took second while Caviart Eva settled for third.

Winning her first race from three starts, Cover Girl has

earned \$25,500 for owners Paul Kelley Racing Stable, T L P Stable, S R F Stable and Lawrence Thomases. The Muscle Hill filly—bred by Marvin Katz, Al Libfeld and Sam Goldband—paid \$4.80 to win.

Expectations topped the first of two KYSS colt dashes with a wire-to-wire victory as the 1-5 favorite.

Driver Mattias Melander had the Marcus Melander trainee on the lead while Hit Show tracked from the pocket approaching a :28.4 opening quarter. The Muscle Hill colt endured no challenge from there, trotting a half in :58.3 and three-quarters in 1:27.3 in progress to a three-length victory in 1:55.3. Hit Show held second while McMatters rallied from off cover for third.

Owned by Vicky Trotting Inc. and bred by Dunroven Stud LLC, Expectations won his second race from six starts, earning \$76,899. He paid \$2.60 to win.

Ready For Moni ranged to the front from the outermost post in the other KYSS colt division and coasted clear of his rivals to win by five-and-a-quarter lengths in 1:57.3.

Driver Jimmy Takter floated the Ready Cash colt towards the front when racing in the center of the course nearing the first turn. Ready For Moni crossed to the lead past a :30.4 opening quarter and slowly widened his lead through a 1:00.3 half and past three-quarters in 1:29.4. Ontopofthehill rallied from a pylon trip to chase the Per Engblom trainee for second while Legion Of Honor, pulling first over around the final turn, took third.

Collecting his third victory from four starts, Ready For Moni has banked \$36,500 for owners John Fielding, Herb Liverman, Bud Hatfield and Lindy Farms Of Connecticut. The Moni Maker Stable bred the colt who paid \$3.20 to win.

KYSS action resumes at Red Mile tonight (Sept. 1) with two divisions for frosh pacing colts and a single split for frosh pacing fillies. The card will start at 7:00 p.m. (EDT).

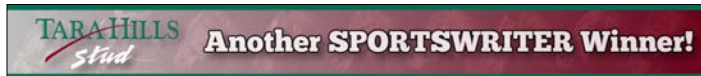
