Underdog vs. Bulldog

*Desperate Man, Canada's 2021 Horse of the Year, returns
in Saturday's Canadian Pacing Derby.*

According to Trevor Henry, his favorite horse is probably the one who accompanied him to Trevor Henry Day, July 23 at Ontario's Hanover Raceway. The appearance by Desperate Man (p, 3, 1:49.3s; \$847,615) and connections helped raise \$12,000 for Canadian Tire youth sports program Jumpstart. The 2021 O'Brien Somebeachsomewhere Horse of the Year, barn name "Slick", spent the afternoon in a temporary stall outside the grandstand, meeting fans. "It was good. A lot of people showed up," said Henry.

Desperate Man hadn't raced since his seventh-place finish in Mohawk's June 11 free-for-all, after which he was found to be sick. Trainer Kathy Cecchin told HRU the gelding's road back from illness couldn't be rushed to meet the timetable for any specific race.

"We just couldn't seem to get back on the right track. Obviously, we did everything that we were supposed to do, but nothing seemed to work... He just wasn't coming around. Our vet's a super nice man, Dr. [John] Hennessey. He finally said, 'I think you're just going to have to wait.' He just didn't respond to the normal treatment for a horse that was sick."

Kathy and her husband, Desperate Man's co-owner/trainer John Cecchin, had to decline their horse's invitation to the June 18 Mohawk Gold Cup.

"We thought, there's no big worries, and then time just kept going, and he just wasn't really coming around," she said. "We didn't even know if we would make this race [Saturday's

Canadian Pacing Derby], with the way things were. All of a sudden it was crunch time."

The season began in more predictable fashion. Last year's Canadian Horse of the Year began his 2022 campaign with a winning 1:53.1s qualifier at Woodbine Mohawk Park on April 22. He finished fourth to Jimmy Freight in his first start of the year, the May 7 Mohawk FFA Pace, then started from the rail in a May 15 Charles Juravinski Memorial elimination at Flamboro Downs. A second-over trip behind first-up American Courage put Desperate Man in position for a three-wide move on the final turn. A perfectly-timed late move put him ahead of 1-9 favorite Charlie May and late-flying Linedrive Hanover at the wire.



The 1:50.2h victory remains Desperate Man's only 2022 win, although he outperformed his 18-1 odds and Flamboro post #8 to finish second to Linedrive Hanover in the \$213,330 Juravinski final May 22. Bulldog Hanover, fourth in the final, would soon find renown as the sport's fastest-ever pacer. Coincidentally, because of scheduling issues, Desperate Man ended up returning from illness and having to qualify against the world champion on Aug. 2.

The Cecchins' gelding, co-owned with daughter and son-in-law Nikki and Paul Davies, was 10 days out from his most recent training mile when he qualified.

"When the entries came out and Bulldog was in our qualifier, I was like 'We're not chasing him today!'" said Kathy. "We did not think our horse was ready to go much more than :53, just because of the timing of everything."

Second by 13 lengths in a 1:53.3 individual mile was enough.

"We thought about qualifying him again instead of trying to race him, because we know where he's got to go, but he's not the same horse in the morning," said Cecchin. "He's no morning glory. It didn't seem ideal to qualify him again because it wasn't like he was going to tear through a mile in :50. He would just walk around out there, so it's not really progressive."

On Aug. 20, Desperate Man was a quick-closing fifth at Mohawk.

"I think that was the first race where he's really looked like himself," said his trainer. "The start when he made the break [the Aug. 13 Mohawk open handicap], we were just kicking stones, like 'Why?!' He's threatened to do that kind of stuff before, so hopefully that's out of his system."

She attributed the break to Desperate Man being "spoiled" by his relaxing life at the family farm.

"It's just us and our daughter and son-in-law [Nikki and Paul Davies] who own half of Desperate Man, and Trevor and Shannon [Henry] who are stabled here."

On Aug. 27, it was underdog vs. Bulldog again in the second of

two Canadian Pacing Derby eliminations at Mohawk. First over from fifth at the half, Desperate Man provided cover to Bulldog Hanover, who chased him around the final turn. The 38-1 shot led until mid-stretch, when the 1-9 favorite rolled past to win in 1:48. Individually timed in 1:48.2, his quickest mile to date, Desperate Man held on for place ahead of Tattoo Artist and Abuckabett Hanover.

Like other allergy-prone horses, Desperate Man prefers cooler air temperatures. Atypical scheduling of the 2021 Pepsi North America Cup due to COVID-19 closures earlier in the summer may have helped his chances in the career-defining victory, but his trainer said a number of factors worked in the gelding's favor that September night.

"I certainly wasn't cocky or anything like that," she recalled. "We thought he was coming in in good form. He paced the last half in :51.3 in his elimination, and we knew he's dopey off the starting gate. We knew if he gets away at the back, the race will be over. We knew it was going to be the trip, and Trevor gave him the perfect trip, getting second-up behind Perfect Sting. I mean, we felt we deserved to be an underdog. Bulldog was tearing everybody's bridle off and Perfect Sting was amazing, so we wanted him to get money and we were going to be happy with that. [Instead], he got the perfect trip and that's what it takes to win a race like that."

Bulldog Hanover and Desperate Man have the same post positions (#4 and #6 respectively) this Saturday (Sept. 3) that they did in the 2021 North America Cup final.

Assessing the deep field of the \$650,000 Canadian Pacing Derby final, Cecchin was hesitant to predict another September upset for her small stable. "I don't know how it will go. Trevor will have to figure it out and hopefully [Desperate Man] behaves himself and can get position and have the trip work out. I don't know if anybody can beat Bulldog, really... He's been so good and, really, the horse of a generation. We'll be talking about him in 20 years because he'll probably have a prolific stud career. There's no knock on him, right?"

Yet the unpredictable business of keeping a top horse on top means the outcome isn't a foregone conclusion to the lifelong horsewoman, who obtained her first training license at age 16.

"Jimmy Freight knows Mohawk inside and out. He's coming into form off a layoff... Warrawee Vital drew the 10 hole, which is sad for his connections," she said. "We thought Linedrive [Hanover] would be here... I don't know how people with a barnful of these top-caliber horses can possibly do it, because we have enough trouble with one."

Despite calling herself a "glorified groom" and letting her husband take Desperate Man for training miles, Kathy is hands-on with Canada's Horse of the Year.

"My whole family was in it," she explained, remembering growing up in a Welwyn, SK harness racing family.

"My grandfather, Chuckie Lewis, I have a picture where he won the 2:24 dash in 1948. Ray Remmen worked for him. My dad, Roy

Cuthill, did labor and got his trainer's license. He owned horses before, but later in life got his trainer's license. And I was horse crazy, as a child. I read every book and I dreamed about horses."

Her respect for Trevor Henry and peers comes from early experience.

"I drove in a couple of 'powder puffs'. I learned early on I was never going to be a driver. Hats off to all the drivers – it was never going to be me."

When Cecchin paddocks Desperate Man, she can't bring herself to watch his races as they unfold in real time. She's dubbed herself "king of the replays." For the Juravinski final, she found a unique hiding place to avoid seeing her horse: "I was hiding between the chip wagon and the men's bathroom." During last Saturday's Derby elim, she stayed in the Mohawk parking lot beside her trailer. This weekend's vantage point is yet to be determined: "I'll see how I feel and I'll bolt somewhere."

But first, the retention barn.

"For us, because it's a retention race, everybody's going to be there, and that's good for him," said Cecchin. "He likes retention. He's a nosy individual... he loves to see what's going on and he just stands with his head up looking at what everybody's doing. It puts him in good humor. We're only about an hour away from Mohawk, so for us it is an easy ship, but everybody will be there the night before."

The \$5,000 starting fee for the Derby was a decision that came down to Kathy's verdict on Desperate Man's form.

"I just thought he deserved a chance. He hasn't done anything wrong, other than he made a break. Things seemed to be going right; John was saying he's getting fitter, he's getting sharper, more like himself."

Her husband also added: "If you don't want to race him in it this year, there's always next year. He's not going anywhere – he's a gelding."

The son of Shadow Play–Dreamlands Latte is the \$20,000 yearling purchase that keeps on giving.

"He's eligible to the Hoosier Pacing Derby and the Breeders Crown," said Cecchin. "He doesn't owe us anything, so what we do is all dependent on how he is. If we think he is competitive, he will race in it. If we don't, he won't. I will not throw him to the wolves. It's family that owns him and everybody only wants what's best for him."

"He's not a business for us. He's done more for us than anyone ever in their wildest dreams could've expected," she added. "There's John, there's my kids, there's my grandkids, and then there's him... Not because he made a million dollars, but because he's him, right? He's funny. He's got a very true heart. It's not because I think he's an ATM... I would have loved him had he been a \$7,000 claimer."

Talking driving strategies with Yannick Gingras

The Hall of Fame reinsman details his winning drive on Beach Glass in the Max Hempt.

In last month's Max Hempt Memorial at Pocono Downs, driver and 2022 Hall of Fame inductee Yannick Gingras was integral in engineering a mild upset win with Beach Glass. In beating what bettors thought was the seemingly invincible 1-5 favorite Bythemissal, the race was an example of how key driver tactics can be.

In the race, Beach Glass with Gingras in tow refused to yield from the rail and parked Bythemissal past a :25.2 opening quarter before forcing that one to relent and settle for a two-hole trip. Again, Gingras had no intention of backing down either when Bythemissal again came at him when he vacated the pocket at about the five-eighths mark of the race. In the end, Bythemissal was game, but so was Beach Glass, who prevailed in the end by a half-length with the strategically better trip.

Gingras and I communicated this week on that race, as well as other driving topics.

Q: In the Hempt, I think that drive and the decision to take it early to Bythemissal won the race. Was the plan always to be on the front end at any cost?

"No, and the funny part about that race is that it never even crossed my mind that there would be no speed from the outside. I thought for sure that Timmy (Tetrack) with Mad Max Hanover would be going really hard, and I figured that Dexter's first time driving Fourever Boy would be leaving hard, too. So, I didn't see the race going the way that it did at all. It wasn't even a thought in my head going in. And then once the gate opened, I had to adjust and in my opinion at that point it became a two-horse race and I figured whoever was going to control the race was going to have the best shot. That's where that strategy came from."

Q: Maybe that’s a good example then of the better drivers being able to be nimble and change when a race unfolds in a way they didn’t first anticipate?

“Absolutely. And there’s no doubt in my mind that you’ve got to be able to adapt, I think that makes a difference in some drivers versus others in that they’re able to adapt on the fly. But for me, all the other guys that I’m driving against every day can do the same and have that same ability. The Hempt was one of those instances where we don’t make plans that can’t be changed. I say all the time, I have a Plan A, Plan B, Plan C, and it rarely happens where everything goes according to your Plan A. It just changes so much and you’ve got to be able to make different decisions at any given time in a race.”

Q: One more question from the Hempt. Usually in these types of racing you’re driving for Ron Burke and in this case he co-owns and trains the horse that you were up against and parked early in that race, Bythemissal. Does that change your thinking at all in how you treat going up against a horse in that situation?

“Absolutely not. When I drive for Brent MacGrath in that instance, that’s who I’m driving for. As far as that race, they (Bythemissal connections) knew that I was doing what I believed was best for me and my horse. I honestly don’t really care during a race who has the other horse, and it should be that way for everyone. I’m driving only for the person I’m driving for, and I’m giving that person the best chance I think I can give them, and that’s just the way it is.”

Q: With that said, do you think that speaks to the competitiveness of drivers?

“You put money on the line, and there’s no favorites. Maybe there’s a mentality out there that some people may have, that we do favors for each other and this and that, but you put money on the line and I don’t care if it’s my dad I’m driving against – I’m driving the horse how I see is best for the horse, and the rest of the guys out there are just like me. We do what we feel is best to win the races.”

Q: Beach Glass was obviously always highly talented, but was still yet to put it all together to the point he has now, when you first started driving him in the North America Cup. Have you observed any changes in him during the past couple of months you’ve been with him?

“Well first, he’s crazy good, number one. And I just think maybe he was a little short in the beginning, from the first time I raced him in the elimination of the North America Cup. The final was one of those things where maybe in hindsight I would have done things differently. That was another example of where I thought it was a two-horse race and looking back maybe I let Pebble Beach go a little too easy and if I took it to him a little bit more then maybe would have done things different, but in that moment I didn’t want to do anything stupid to jeopardize being second. I’m also certain I choked him and shut his air off in the final turn. I’m not saying he would have won but maybe he wouldn’t have been beat by as much. But I do think my horse has been getting better and better and it started then. I’ve also learned from the horse there, I’ve adjusted my driving a little bit, driving him more aggressively and he’s liked that and at the same time he’s continued to get better.”

Q: This time of year you're routinely listed on multiple horses in a given race for top trainers, most notably Ronnie Burke and Nancy Takter for example. What goes into your decisions and how much stock should bettor's place on those decisions?

"It all depends, and you can look at me as an example. If I'm picking a horse that is owned or trained by Burke, well a lot of times I'm picking that horse just because of that reason; it may not be related to much else. There's definitely a loyalty factor and the same goes for a lot of other drivers also that are loyal to certain barns; that's the way that it is. But now, if there are times where I pick off a Burke horse, then it probably is because I do believe that the other horse is better. But then, half the time he still beats me anyway, so it's one of those things that you have to be smart and careful how much you read into those decisions."

Q: This Saturday at Woodbine Mohawk you drive Atlanta as usual in the Maple Leaf Trot and this is the first time she'll be going up against the likes of Alrajah One. Do you think she'll be up to the task?

"It's going to be hard; this horse Alrajah One is a freak. He's been ultra-impressive since he's got here. We drew right outside

of Alrajah One and we'll see how the race plays out. She can do it either way obviously and in an ideal trip maybe I'd like to follow him, but that'll depend on what he's trying to do as well. We're going to have to get lucky and he's going to have to come back to us a little bit to be able to beat him. But she's been good. She was great three starts ago in the Ms Versatility and then I over-raced her on Hambletonian Day in the Steele Memorial; I think that one was my fault. And then last week in Canada they said she was really good, and so I'm happy with the way she's coming into the race. But she is 7 years old now, so I may have to take it a little easier on her and again that was my mistake on Hambo day, so I'll be trying to give her a better trip this time to give her a chance to get it done."

Q: Last week at Woodbine Mohawk you drove a really nice looking 2-year-old Save America to a win in the Nassagaweya Stakes. That was only his third career start and you've driven him in all his races to date including his baby races. What are your impressions thus far of him?

"I really liked him a lot last week and thought he raced really well. He was very good in both of his qualifiers earlier in the summer and I was very happy with his first couple of starts. He won in 1:49.4 in his second start at the Meadowlands. The track was obviously fast that day but he did it pretty easy. And then last week, there's some little things we're going to change on him heading into the next few starts, equipment-wise. He was a little bit bumpy at times last week at Mohawk and he's never done that before, so we're just going to make some small changes, change his shoes around a little bit. And other than that I think the sky's the limit for him. He's got tremendous ability, he's got big lungs, he's nice to drive, and he's just dumb enough to – and I mean that in a good way – he just doesn't know what he's doing yet which is great because you don't want them to be too keyed up and too ready too early anyway. And so I think he's coming into his own and just have to hope he stays healthy and sound. I think he'll do very good things."

Insider information

Did inside information make The Meadowlands' Championship Meet better?

In June, The Big M partnered with Marty Marsh's Inside Harness to get more information to their fans.

While it's impossible to quantify exactly how successful the partnership was since there's no way to tell how much money was wagered as a result of the team up, there are some numbers that can be examined.

Once the collaboration was announced, www.insideharness.com immediately saw 700 new bettors sign up, nearly doubling their clientele.

"It went a little bit better than I expected, actually," said Marsh. "I had people contact me, asking me to do it for the thoroughbreds. I'm like, 'No, I don't do thoroughbreds, just harness racing.' It's too much work and I don't love thoroughbreds like I love harness."

"So as time went on, I've gotten emails and contacts from thoroughbred bettors that are now betting harness along with thoroughbreds and they weren't before. If we can pull thoroughbred bettors over to harness, they're big bettors, and there's lots of them, so it would definitely help in the long run."

Marsh believes that getting The Meadowlands, the top harness track in the world, involved with Inside Harness intrigued the thoroughbred players.

The success or failure of Inside Harness is totally dependent upon the participation of the horsemen. All did not embrace this opportunity the same, and, in fact, some refused to comment at all, but those that did, like trainer Ron Burke, driver Scott Zeron and members of the GSY driving club, can see the ultimate benefit.

"Anything new that we're up for trying, I'll try," said Burke. "It can't hurt. I do it as honest as I can and I do think I have a good feel for my horses. What I say I honestly believe. I'm not always going to be right, but as a trainer I know my horses probably better than even the drivers do."

"I know when my horses have been at the wrong track or they're moving to a better class or when a horse has had a really bad week and I say a horse has had a bad week, I know it. He's fine to race, but is he going to be at the top of his game? No. Very rarely when I say a horse has had a bad week do they race good. I've always said my barn is very train good, race good, train bad, race bad."

Zeron, last seen sharing his expert comments live as co-host for part of The Meadowlands' Hambletonian Day simulcast show, is hopeful to return to action in October as he continues to heal from a bad accident in late July.

"My thing is, you can never give enough information," said Zeron. "You can always give the public more information and they can use what they want."

When it comes to making comments for Inside Harness, drivers can be in a tough spot because if they say they're planning to race a horse from behind or off a helmet and instead leave, the public could perceive them to be less than honest, but Zeron thinks it's possible to be informative without discussing strategy.

When host Dave Little asked Zeron if he thought Tetrack would fire out of the 10-hole with Fashion Schooner in the Oaks, Zeron responded: "He certainly is" and went on to explain that regardless of the odds, Andy McCarthy would be leaving with longshot Mon Cheval (post 9, 75-1) because her trainer Nancy Takter said she was at her best when you were aggressive with her. "So, if the nine's pushing out really hard, I think Timmy has no choice but to push over top of the nine," said Zeron, who predicted the start perfectly.

Marsh believes that even basic or unimaginative driver comments like "I don't know the horse," are still beneficial to a gambler.

"It does give the public information that he doesn't know this horse, he's never driven it," said Marsh. "There's always something you can say. Even if you just said horse had a good week, that's enough for me. If I'm a bettor and I know the horse has had a good week, that's a go for me, I'll bet that horse."

"Over the years I've said this 100 million times, I'd rather have a guy tell me my horse is not going to do very well tonight than I'm going to win. Half the time they're not going to win but when they say they're not going to do very well tonight, 99 per



cent of the time they don't do very well. You can throw them out of your handicapping."

Towards the end of the Championship Meet, participation from some of The Meadowlands' horsemen declined and some just stopped altogether.

Marsh knows he will never get comments from 100 per cent of the participants but does wish they viewed it more the way other athletes do and understood it was for the promotion and betterment of a sport which has so much to offer.

"To be honest, part of racing's problem is that the transparency is not there," said Marsh. "Anybody can win on any given day. If it was a perfect science people would lose interest in it. That's what makes it great."

Timo Nurmos' exciting Derby weekend

Finnish/Swedish trainer Timo Nurmos knows how to prepare horses for the really big races in Europe and earlier this year he was inducted into the Nordic Hall Of Fame of Harness Racing.

The trainer of horses such as Readly Express, Villiam and Calgary Games has a spectacular weekend ahead of him this week, since his horses, to a very high degree, compete in the prestigious Derby races in both Finland and Sweden.

Nurmos, who is title defender in the Swedish Derby (Calgary Games won 2021) starts his Derby weekend in Finland on Saturday (Sept. 3), where he has two shots in the \$240,000 Finnish Derby at Verno racetrack.

E.L.Jetpack (E L Titan) is perhaps Nurmos' best chance in the 2,620 meters long race, where some very interesting trotters show up as opponents.

From Helsinki Saturday to Malmö, Sweden on Sunday (Sept. 4) afternoon, that's the plan for Nurmos and the Sunday card at Jägersro is even more thrilling for the dominant Derby trainer.

In \$400,000 Derbystoet for 4-year-old mares, Nurmos trains six out of 12 contenders, which is a feat hard to accomplish for anyone in the game. The probable favorite among his trotters is Lara Boko, who impressed a lot in her elimination at Jägersro on Aug. 23.

It's not a wild guess to say that a Nurmos trained horse will win Derbystoet 2022 and he chases his third win in the race.

And it's not impossible that Nurmos will capture the two big trophies at Jägersro Sunday afternoon. In the \$800,000 Derby, he presents an undefeated 4-year-old Muscle Hill son, who looked like a star trotter in the elimination over 2,640 meters on Aug. 23. Lulius Boko has not more than some \$40,000 on his account after eight lifetime starts and the

feeling is that we've seen this before. Last year, Calgary Games entered the Derby with pretty much the same background as Lulius Boko and then proved to be totally dominant when he faced more merited trotters in the big race in Malmö.

If Lulius Boko wins the Derby, it will be Timo Nurmos' fifth victory in the race and he can really do it. Lulius Boko draw number 4 in the Derby while the probable favorite — and crop dominant so far — Francesco Zet will start from post 5 behind the gate.

Caring comes naturally to Tami Sepper

In horse racing, there is a lot you can't control that has an impact on your success. A trip doesn't go your way, equipment can malfunction, and a host of other factors.

One thing you can control that has a direct impact on a horse's success is its day-to-day care. In Chantal Mitchell's barn, Tami Sepper is one of the caretakers charged with ensuring this piece of the puzzle is accomplished.

Wearing a Little Brown Jug t-shirt, black leggings, and matching crocs, Sepper drapes a Bemer blanket around Control Heaven, who's in cross ties in Mitchell's barn at Classy Lane Training Centre, in Puslinch, ON.

Bemer blankets are designed to improve a horse's circulation, and Sepper wraps the 4-year-old gelding's body and legs in the blue and orange material.

"My favourite part of being a groom is looking after the horses," said Sepper. "Horses will show you how well you are taking care of them and give it back to you in the end. That's my favourite part, working on them and then seeing the results at the end of the week."

Sepper has been a caretaker for over a decade, getting her start after her friend's father, Paul Harrison, introduced her to the game.

"They had some standardbreds, and he said one day, 'Why don't you come out?' So I went out jogged my first horse for him, Whos

Legacy," said Sepper. "He threw the reins at me and said drive on. So that was my start in the horse racing business."

Sepper cut her teeth in racing in the Barrie area, mostly based out of Georgian Downs before moving to Acton in 2010, getting a job with Jeff Gillis, and then Cory Johnson.

Over the years she's worked for many trainers including Dr. Ian Moore and Blake MacIntosh. She's been in her current role with Mitchell's barn for about 18 months. But no matter who the trainer is, the ins and outs of being a caretaker remain the same.

"First thing in the morning we feed them their breakfast, and sweep up leftover hay from the night before," said Sepper. "Then we turn them out, do their stalls, and water buckets, set feeds, bring them in, get them harnessed to jog or train. Then after they're done track work put them away."

Taking care of animals, and people comes naturally to Sepper. In fact, she's going back to school in the fall to become a Personal Support Worker. A natural progression from her time in the horse racing business.

"I just like helping people, or horses," said Sepper. "Just taking care of them, that's my route to go."

The New York Sire Stakes visited Batavia Downs for the final time this year on Wednesday (Aug. 31) with a dozen 2-year-old trotting colts and geldings competing for the remaining spots in the finals to be held during the Day of Champions at Tioga Downs on Saturday (Sept. 10).

In the first \$52,500 division, **Cecil Hanover** (Chapter Seven—Columbia) looked sharp getting his first lifetime and NYSS win.

Cecil Hanover (Ake Svanstedt) left and led the field to the quarter where Met Your Request (Andy Miller) assumed the top position as the clock read :29. Positions remained unchanged to the half when Svanstedt tipped Cecil Hanover and regained control of the race past the five-eighths. At that point Met Your Request and Tillio's Action (Mile Merton) both made breaks and Cecil Hanover was on top by 4-½ lengths going by three-quarters in 1:29. Coming off the far turn the race was over as Cecil Hanover trotted home on his own and won easily by 4-¾ lengths in a lifetime mark of 1:58.2.

Cecil Hanover (\$6.80) is owned by S R F Stable, Midnight Sun Partners, Ake Svanstedt and Jorgen Sparredal. Svanstedt also trains the colt that was bred by Hanover Shoe Farms.

The second \$53,500 leg went to **Onion Gum** (Chapter Seven—Princessa) who also scored his first NYSS win as well.

Jax Spratt (Kevin Cummings) took command and went :28.4 and 1:00 to the half as Sevecheetah (Trond Smedshammer) and The Strawboss (Jim Morrill Jr.) followed close behind. The first to pull was Onion Gum (Jordan Stratton) who moved from fourth and was quickly second and only one length off by three-quarters. It was a real race around the last turn and when they hit the straight three horses had a shot. Jax Spratt was still on top but Onion Gum was wearing him down. Sevecheetah then found room at the pylons and was barreling towards the wire. But Onion Gum chewed up the most ground to the line and won by one length in 1:59.4.

Onion Gum (\$4.20) is owned by S R F Stable (who was also part owner of Cecil Hanover), Order By Stable (who bred the colt) and Mario Mazza. Lucas Wallin trains Onion Gum.

Jordan Stratton continued his driving dominance at Batavia Downs on Wednesday after winning another four races on the card. Beside his victory with the aforementioned Onion Gum, Stratton also scored with How About Murph (1:56.2, \$7.40), Dashintothebeach N (1:54.1, \$5.00) and the aptly named Grand Slam Hero (2:02.2, \$16.00). Stratton was in town last Friday (Aug. 26) and registered a hat trick during the night, giving him a total of seven wins in his last 15 drives in Genesee County.

Slightly dismissed at the betting windows, Brookview Darius returned \$26.80 to his backers.

Trained by Erv Miller, the gelded son of Swan For All—Witty's Winner recorded his third win from seven seasonal starts. The 1:57.1 final time equaled his career best. Brookview Darius has now earned \$65,188 in his young career and is owned in partnership by Kales Co., Engel Stable of IL, and L. Willinger.

Two-year-old trotting fillies took center stage at Hoosier on Tuesday (Aug. 30) with two \$67,000 Indiana Sires Stakes divisions on the evening's 14-race card. The freshman fillies have now completed their fourth round of their eight-round series.

After an uncharacteristic break in the first turn by the heavy favorite, Yo Beth D, in the opening division, the race shifted to a wide open affair. Meadowbrook Rose and Sam Widger protected their rail position through the opening panel in :28.4. **Helpineedsomebody** and Michael Oosting moved to the front just before the half in :59.3 but would yield the lead to Marys Magic and Kyle Wilfong before the three-quarters in 1:29.2. Turning for home, Helpineedsomebody was back out and on the attack. Using a :28.4 final quarter, Helpineedsomebody trotted steady to the wire and held off a hard charging Swan Fancy and Peter Wrenn to get the victory in 1:58.2. Sent off at odds of 23-1, Helpineedsomebody returned \$49.80 for the upset victory.

In the second division, **Helpoftheseason** and driver Peter Wrenn went gate to wire to score in 1:55.1 and remain undefeated this season. Leaving from post three, Helpoftheseason dictated fractions of :27.2, :56.4 and 1:26.3 before feeling a threat from the rest of the field. Picaboo Lady and Trevor Smith were on the attack first-over but Helpoftheseason wasn't finished. Using a :28.3 final quarter, Helpoftheseason repelled Picaboo Lady and also a late surge from Country Mamma and Kyle Wilfong to get the victory. Tim Tetrick records 13,000th driving victory

Tim Tetrick became only the seventh North American driver to reach 13,000 career victories when he guided Sir Isaac Newton to victory in the fourth race at Harrah's Philadelphia on Wednesday afternoon (Aug. 31).

The Captaintreacherous–Newborn Sassy (a \$1M winner) 2-year-old gelding, co-owned by Tim Tetrick LLC along with Jo Ann Looney-King and trained by Jim King Jr., had not raced in 35 days, and Tetrick followed the “gravitational” pull of the pylons with Sir Isaac Newton. Tetrick rallied the horse from sixth all the way up the inside, pacing his own back fractions of :54.3 - :27.1 to post a head victory over Storm The Court in breaking his maiden in 1:53.4.

Tetrick, 40, has won seven driving dash titles in the history of Harrah's Philly, and is well ahead this year in the pursuit of his

eightth seasonal title. He also has eight local UDR crowns. The countless superstars he has driven have under his guidance earned just shy of \$249 million, third on the all-time list.

Zubrod said that pacers not to be missed include Hip 147, the Bettor’s Delight filly first foal from the very fast Captaintreacherous lass Key West p,2,1:51.1. Another is Hip 324, the Captaintreacherous three-quarter brother to none other than 2022’s \$1,000,000 North America Cup winner Pebble Beach.
