The Captain is a Determined Winner; Jug Plans Up in the Air

NICHOLS, NY—For Captaintreacherous it was as much a dogfight as a victory. Yesterday at Tioga Downs in the Cane Pace, it was his grit and determination that got him to the wire in front, a winner by a neck over 46-1 shot Word Power.

"I don't get worried that the horse is ever going to get passed," trainer Tony Alagna said. "I know he will fight tooth and nail to get to wire."

Captaintreacherous' win was the highlight on a late

summer day when the Shady Daisy went to the Casie Coleman-trained Scandalous Hanover and local favorite Jim Marohn Jr. picked up a check for \$25,000 after beating his more heralded rivals in the drivers' championship.

Captaintreacherous was coming off his first loss of the year, a nose defeat in the Battle of the Brandywine at Pocono Downs. But his connections argued that he was done in by a poor trip that night and that his Pocono performance was among his best ever. They vowed he would be on top of his game at Tioga, and they were right.

Driven by Tim Tetrick, Captaintreacherous left from post two and went right for the lead. But he had company in the form of Varadero Hanover, who was making his first start for Ron Burke. The Burke colt did everything he could to make life miserable for The Captain. With Tetrick refusing to yield, the pair went the first quarter in 26.2 and the half in 54.

Driven by Yannick Gingras, Varadero Hanover was done well before the final turn, but there was a fresh challenge in Wake Up Peter, Captaintreacherous' stablemate. Driven by Ron Pierce, he made a bold first over move and drew along side the favorite. Just as he did with Varadero Hanover,

Captaintreacherous fought wake Up Peter into submission only to face still another challenge, this one from Word Power. Driven by Jody Jamieson, Word Power appeared ready to go right past the leader but Captaintreacherous refused to let that happen and won by a neck.

"He's a lazy horse and he'll never draw off and win by a lot," said Myron Bell, the racing manager for the Captaintreacherous syndicate. "He likes to see a horse along side him and every time a horse makes a move at him he digs in and keeps going. As long as he wins, that's what matters."

Knowing his horse and his driver, Alagna remained confident through what looked like an unsettling stretch drive for The Captain's connections.

"I think I told everybody that this horse can go as long as he needs to go," he said. "He's got the staying power and the lung capacity to go all day. When there was that horse parked outside of him that was not ideal, that was not the way I wanted to see it go, but great horses find a way to win and he's proven that all along."

The entry of Captaintreacherous and Wake Up Peter paid \$3.30. Wake Up Peter finished third and the time was 1:49.2. So taxed by his battle with Captaintreacherous, Varadero Hanover finished last.

The question now for Captaintreacherous is what's next? His connections have been yet to announce a post-Cane Pace schedule, which probably has the Little Brown Jug team worried. Captaintreacherous has been carefully managed all year and it wouldn't be the least bit surprising to see his connections bypass the Jug, a two-heat race on a half-mile track.

"The Jug is certainly an historic race, a great race," Bell said. "But we have other venues that we are also looking at. We have a couple of weeks in Lexington, we have the Breeders Crown and there's also next year. We're going to make an executive decision in another week to 10 days."

Passing the Jug could hinder Captaintreacherous' Horse of the Year bid. He is currently locked in a neck-and-neck battle with Bee A Magician for that honor and Bee A Magician won again last night at Mohawk.

"If we get the honor of being Horse of the Year fine," Bell said "If we don't and there's a better horse out there that's fine, too."

Five races earlier on the card Shebestingin looked like the one to beat in the \$122,212 Shady Daisy and was sent off as the odds-on favorite. She put in a good effort, but it wasn't good enough.

With Shebestingin checking in third, the red hot Scandalous Hanover won by a neck over Ms Caila J Fra. The Dragon Again filly has now won all four of her starts since being bought privately by trainer Casie Coleman and a partnership of owners. This was her first stakes win.

Ironically, Coleman was not at first interested in buying Scandalous Hanover but took her as part of package because she wanted a 2-year-old named Ewald Hanover.

"When we bought her we were trying to buy a horse named Ewald Hanover from the same owners," she said. "We weren't agreeing on the price so we wound up making a package deal so that there was a price we could all be happy with. We call this filly 'the throw in.'"

Scandalous Hanover was supplemented to the race at a cost of \$7,500.

Nine of the best drivers in North America were at Tioga yesterday for the stakes and for the second leg of a drivers' competition that began at Vernon Downs. The bragging rights and a check for \$25,000 went to Jim Marohn Jr., who was representing Tioga and drove his eyeballs out to beat his much more famous competitors. Marohn won it all when taking the final race in the competition with Diamond Star.

"This has been an absolute dream come true, racing against these guys and being the last one standing," Marohn said. "I couldn't have asked for anything better."

CAMPBELLVILLE, ONTARIO – Bee A Magician lived up to her name Monday night at Mohawk Racetrack, overcoming a tough post and brushing down the lane to set a record in the \$216,429 Simcoe Stakes for three-year-old filly trotters.

Driven by Rick Zeron, the daughter of Kadabra out of the Balanced Image mare Beehive, Bee A Magician added yet

another laurel to her many achievements while raising her sophomore unbeaten streak to 11. She set a stakes record with a time of 1:52 3/5. Earlier this year she set a world record for three-year-old

In her latest victory, the daughter of Kadabra out of the Balanced Image mare Beehive started from the 11 hole in the bulky field of 12. In the past five years at Mohawk only 8.2% have won from that post. Mind you, it's a rarity that a race has that many starters, but it still means having to start from the second tier and hoping for a lot of luck.

Sent postward as the prohibitive 1-2 favorite, Bee A Magician followed the pack, but was seventh by eight lengths while double parked after three quarters and fifth by four lengths at the top of the stretch. But she found her footing and brushed by pacesetter Shared Past in mid-stretch to win by 1¾ lengths. Shared Past set fractions of 27, 56 1/5 and 1:23 4/5.

"It's confidence building driving Bee A Magician because I think she's the best three-year-old trotting filly in the world this year," Zeron told Harness Racing Update afterward. "I wasn't fortunate enough to drive her down in the Meadowlands (for the Del Miller or Hambletonian Oaks), but like (driver) Brian Sears says she does everything perfectly. She can overcome a bad race and still win like she did tonight coming out of the 11-hole. There was every excuse in the world to get beat tonight. She was about eight lengths behind, but she just puts her head down and goes...I was very concerned about leaving from post 11. I was very concerned the last three days about that. Fortunately I got away and I wasn't pinned down (on the inside) and that was the biggest thing I was concerned about.

"I've always been bragging all year that she can kick in and she did," Zeron added. "There's a lot of great fun driving a filly like this because she can go to the front or you can race her from behind and she gets home just like she's leading. There's always pressure whether she's going to get beat, but she just going to keep on winning and fortunately enough she keeps making me look good. I just can't say enough about her because she just keeps doing everything that I ask her to do, and when I know she's getting a little bit tired and I ask her to do more she does."

Bee A Magician, trained by Nifty Norman for owners Mel Hartman, Herb Liverman and David McDuffee, collected \$108,214 to surpass \$1.7 million in career earnings. She was a \$90,000 yearling purchase.

"I've driven quite a few good trotters in my life and she ranks right up there beside the best ones or she's above them," Zeron added.

Bee A Magician paid \$3.00 to win, \$2.20 to place and \$2.10 to show, Shared Past, the second choice in the field at just under 3-1, paid \$3.20 to place and \$2.40 to show. Motown Muscle, sent off at more than 14-1, paid \$3.10 to show. The exacta paid \$8.80 and the trifecta \$32.30

I LUV THE NITELIFE HEADED TO JUGETTE

I Luv The Nitelife won the \$216,429 Simcoe Stakes for three-year-old filly pacers by a length in 1:50 flat and will now be pointed to the Juliette.

Driven by Tim Tetrick, who earlier in the day won the Cane

Pace with star three-year-old colt pacer Captaintreachorous, I Luv The Nitelife left from the one hold and was settled comfortably in fourth. She gained the lead just before the halfway point and was never threatened afterward.

She went postward in the field of 12 at just under 1-5 and paid \$2.30 to win and \$2.30 to place. There was no show wagering. Aunt Caroline, a 75-1 outsider, raced second and paid \$27.70. Love Canal, a 14-1 shot, finished third. The exacta paid \$53.20 and the trifecta \$346.50. Aunt Caroline had the lead after a quarter mile in 27 2/5. I Luv The Nitelife paced the half in 54 2/5 and three-quarters in 1:22 2/5.

Trained by Chris Ryder for owners Richard Young and Joanne Young, the daughter of Rocknroll Hanover out of the Camluck mare Lisjune has won 10 of 12 races this year. She also increased her current win streak to nine.

"She's been racing tougher, but these are nice horses and you've still got to race the race," Richard Young said. "She's tough. I love racing here. I've had a tremendous record here."

Young said if I Luv The Nitelife stays sound, he'll race her for another two or three years, but the immediate goal is the Juliette.

I Luv The Nitelife has been driven exclusively this year by Tetrick.

"She can (win) from anywhere, but when you're the dead favorite you've got to make sure you control the race," Tetrick said. "I'm very, very fortunate to get to drive the horses that I do thanks to the owners and trainers that put a lot of faith in me. Fortunately for me I get to drive the best and it's always fun to win."

I Luv The Nitelife has won \$863,050 this year and has banked more than \$1.5 million in her career. She was purchased a yearling for \$60,000.
