# PERICULUM aims for International growy

On Saturday, the trotter is vying to become the first U.S. horse to win the MGM Yonkers International Trot in eight years.

The most recent horse to represent the U.S. and win the MGM Yonkers International Trot, Resolve in 2016, captured the million-dollar race in his first start after winning the Maple Leaf Trot. Periculum, one of two horses representing the U.S. in Saturday's (Sept. 7) edition of the invitational event, will attempt to do the same.

Periculum rolled to a 1:50.4 victory in the Maple Leaf Trot this past weekend at Woodbine Mohawk Park and will look to add the International Trot to his résumé this weekend when he visits MGM Yonkers Raceway's half-mile oval to meet nine rivals at the distance of 1¼ miles. The 5-year-old stallion will start from post 10, in the second tier, with Scott Zeron driving for trainer Marcus Melander. He is 5-1 on the morning line.

Melander won the 2018 International Trot with Cruzado Dela Noche.

"Hopefully, we can get it done again," Melander said. "It's very exciting. When they're going for a million dollars and you get invited and the horse is in good form, you've got to say yes and give it a shot. I'm very happy that they wanted us in the race."

Periculum has won six of 10 races this season and earned \$293,522 for owners Brixton Medical Inc. and Holly Lane Stud East LTD. The son of Muscle Hill—Amour Heiress, out of the family of Hall of Fame broodmare Amour Angus, was a multiple Grand Circuit winner at ages 2 and 3 in North America before racing



overseas last year. He set his mark of 1:50.3 as a 3-year-old, which tied for fourth fastest among sophomore male trotters in 2022.

For his career, Periculum has won 11 of 43 races and banked \$752,834.

"He's always been a good horse, but now that he's 5, he just feels so much stronger," said Melander, who also trained Periculum

prior to his year abroad. "It feels like his body has developed even more, and he's been racing good all year."

Periculum heads to the International Trot off back-to-back victories at Mohawk, where he won his Maple Leaf Trot elimination by  $4\frac{3}{4}$  lengths in 1:51.2 and won the final by  $2\frac{1}{4}$  lengths with a time that missed the Canadian record by only two-fifths of a second.

In his start prior to visiting Canada, Periculum finished third in the Sebastian K Invitational at Mohegan Pennsylvania's Pocono Downs, where he started from post 8 and was beaten by three-quarters-of-a-length by Jiggy Jog S — a 5-year-old mare who is the **5-2 morning-line favorite** in the International Trot.

"This will be his fourth week in a row, so he'll just have an easy week," Melander said. "It feels like he can handle it. He's very easy on himself and he's a good traveler."

Periculum has raced from off the pace in all but one of his 10 races this year, which made the post-10 draw less of a concern for Melander.

"It could have been better; it could have been worse," Melander said. "He's not that big of a leaver, and I think some drivers will leave in that race, so I think he'll be OK. We'll need some luck, of course, from there. We'll just hope they go at it a little bit on the front and Scott can find a spot. Scott knows the track well, so he knows where he needs to put him and when he can pull the right line.

"Hopefully, the horse will be racing as good as he's been racing lately."

Zeron has appeared in the International Trot on three occasions, all with Marion Marauder. They finished second to Twister Bi in 2017, third in 2019 and fifth in 2018.

The MGM Yonkers International Trot is race 5 on the 11-race program and has an estimated post of 2 p.m. (EDT). The full field, with country represented plus listed driver, trainer and morning line, is as follows:

#### Penultimate card of the Big M's "Mini Meet" sure to be a classic

The four-card Meadowlands meet includes tonight's New Jersey Classic Series finals before wrapping up on Saturday.

Before The Meadowlands' four-day "Mini Meet" comes to an end on Saturday (Sept. 7), there's still \$1.6 million to hand out in the finals of the New Jersey Classic Series (NJCS).

The eight finals for 2- and 3-year-old males and females, will take place tonight (Sept. 6), with the trotters going for \$250,000 per race and the pacers \$150,000. In addition, the 2-year-old colt trotters and freshman and sophomore filly trotters each have a \$100,000 consolation.

Typically, a card of this caliber featuring such stars as Hambletonian Oaks champ Warrawee Michelle, Earl Beal winner Sig Sauer and Shady Daisy victor Rocket Deo, would be a Big M Saturday night special, but with Sept. 7 already being so stakes laden, for the good of the sport, The Meadowlands had Friday on their mind.

"Nick [Salvi] and Scott [Warren] do a great job with that; they're very logical," Meadowlands chief operating officer/general manager Jason Settlemoir said of the track's director/administrator of stakes races and racing secretary, respectively. "Obviously, we try to pivot if we can, if it makes sense for the sport. That's a difficult job that Nick and Scott have.

"We try to pay attention so we're not bumping into other people's big races."

Since racetracks do not operate in a bubble, every choice by every track has an impact and, according to Settlemoir, finding a way to keep everyone rowing in the same direction is important.

"Honestly, if they base completely off of us and what we're doing, that would be fantastic, but that's not the real world," Settlemoir said with a laugh. "My biggest thing is being able to get the horses raced and get them in front of the proper audience customer-wise, so that our customers can benefit from it, too.

"I mean, look, I'd be lying if I said that I didn't feel that there



were too many races at different places, but I try to look at all of the different racing opportunities as a good thing so that the owners can get their investment back on these horses."

This is the third year for the NJCS and the second straight with an elims and finals format. These lucrative races are available to those sired in New Jersey as well those eligible to the New Jersey Standardbred Development Fund (NJSDF) races along with those by sires that stand and are registered in the state of New Jersey.

According to a Meadowlands press release sent out in 2023: "Adding the NJSDF horses will provide a welcome earning opportunity for the foals of mares that are housed within the state of New Jersey, whether sired by a stallion standing in New Jersey or not as well as providing a larger pool of horses eligible for nomination.

"The NJCS is an early closing event, which means a fresh start each year, so horses may be nominated at age 3 regardless of whether they were made eligible as a 2-year-old or not."

For Settlemoir and his team, the first thing they look at when scheduling races like the NJCS is to not bump into another stakes race, which sometimes is impossible.

"At the end of the day, I want to try to get these horses where they have the drivers that they're supposed to have," Settlemoir said. "I don't think it's fair to the owners if they've been having a driver drive and then all of a sudden, another driver has to drive because of a stakes race somewhere else. I don't think that's fair to the horse. I don't think it's fair to the owner and I don't think it's fair to the customer, either."

Following a five-week break, The Meadowlands will return on Friday (Oct. 18) with a special day card featuring Breeders Crown eliminations with a first race post of 12:30 p.m. There will also be Crown elims on Saturday (Oct. 19) with the finals for the \$7-million event the following weekend on Oct. 25 and 26.

"We've been planning for it since we signed the agreement with the Breeders Crown Society," Settlemoir said. "John [Campbell] and Moira [Fanning] and the team have been working right along and we're excited about it."

Settlemoir was only too happy to start discussing the yearend divisional championship series, but added that it's nice to still have a little time before it all comes down to the Breeders Crown.

"I'm glad we've got what, how many weeks still, six?" Settlemoir said. "But, it's never too soon to start talking about it. It's when all the stars come together and a lot of the year-end awards are predicated upon those Breeders Crown championships and it's always an honor to have those races.



Dexter Dunn is heading back Down Under.


But don't panic, it's just a visit and a "working" holiday.



Since the series was unveiled a few months back, organizers Racing Queensland's wish for it to stir strong international interest has come true.

Applications for one of the 10 slots in the Ultimate Drivers Challenge have come from all around the world.

Until now, those bidding for slots and the drivers they nominate have remained private.

But race sponsor Ladbrokes, part of the global Entain business, snared a slot as part of its support for the event.

Its chief executive officer, passionate harness owner and supporter Dean Shannon, set his sights on landing Dunn to drive in the Ladbrokes slot from Day One.

Although he lives in Australia, Shannon almost exclusively races his horses in New Zealand. His best pacer, Merlin, won the \$1 million Race By Grins at Cambridge in April and is one of the main contenders for the \$1-million New Zealand Cup in November.

Dunn, who turned 35 on Sept. 1, drove 2,226 winners in NZ and 55 in Australia before moving to the U.S. to continue his career in 2018

Significantly, Dunn's previous trips to Australia from NZ were to chase major races and his wins included two of the country's biggest races, the Miracle Mile and Hunter Cup, with former superstar pacer Christen Me in 2015 and '16.

In a quirky piece, Dunn's first win as a driver came in Australia aboard The Ultimate One at regional track Geelong in September, 2006.

How, might you ask? It's because he had a stint working with top Victorian trainer Andy Gath as a late teen. The pair remain the best of mates.

Dunn's deeds in NZ are legendary with 10 driving premierships, four junior driving titles and even a Canterbury Sportsman of the Year title – which is almost unthinkable in the rugby-crazed region of NZ's South Island.

Four Dan Patch Driver of the Year awards and over 2,000 wins later, Dunn has made quite a mark in the U.S.

Dunn is no stranger to Albion Park, the host track of the Ultimate Driver Challenge, either.

Literally while packing his bags to move his life and career to the U.S. in mid-2018, Dunn made a hit-and-run visit to Brisbane's home of harness racing to drive Let It Ride to win Queensland's biggest race, the Group 1 Blacks A Fake.

"I've been there a few times, it'll be great to get back," Dunn said. "It's a quiet time of year here [in the U.S.] in January and

February, so it fits really well. I'd heard some talk about this new driver series in Australia and pretty much straight away someone from Ladbrokes rang to ask if I was interested.

"It's certainly something different and to be bundled into two nights makes it easy to take it in. It's an honor to get the call-up and I can't wait to be part of it and catch-up with lots of people I know when I get down there."

The Ultimate Driver Challenge consists of 20 races across two nights for just 10 drivers at Albion Park with over \$250,000 in prize money up for grabs. First prize is \$100,000 and slot holders will receive \$1,000 for each race win.

Applications for the nine remaining slots (Ladbrokes already had a slot), which cost \$20,000 each, closed on July 31.

When it was launched, champion North American drivers Tim Tetrick and Jody Jamieson were among those to endorse it.

Albion Park chief Ken Rutherford was thrilled to learn Dunn was a lock for the series.

"Dexter is an outstanding choice and fit for the inaugural Ladbrokes Ultimate Driver," he said. "He covers so many markets, being a Kiwi whose last win in Australia was at Albion Park in The Blacks A Fake in 2018 to now being one of the biggest names in North American harness racing.

"We are humbled by the interest from across the globe. We received several applications that were internationally focused ranging from North America to Europe along with applications from other Australian states and here in Queensland.

"All applicants indicated how they would promote the Ultimate Driver and harness racing in general which has provided the selection panel with plenty to think about ahead of announcing the other nine slot holders. To ensure reach and engagement we are aiming to strike a balance between slot holders that are internationally, interstate and locally focused."

The other successful slot holders will be announced Sept. 18.

# James Miller riding a lucky streak with Brookview Fancy



Next month, James Miller will mark eight years in the business as an owner. The Dixon, KY resident frequented racetracks for years, but finally pursued ownership on the advisement of his wife. Recently, Miller-owned pacers have found success at Harrah's Hoosier Park. Then-sophomore Soaring Now was named 2022 Indiana Pacer of the Year after a strong campaign, and this season freshman filly Brookview Fancy has risen to the top of her Indiana Sires Stakes division, collecting her third victory in the state's top program Wednesday (Aug. 28).

"I just got lucky," Miller said of purchasing the freshman. "Luck is 80 per cent of it."

Miller is all too familiar with the role luck plays when horses line up behind the starting gate. He was born into a racing family and later became a regular at the track playing the ponies.

"My mom and dad owned and trained horses from about 1970-75," Miller said. "They quit when I started school. We lived a block away from Audubon Raceway. I was there every night

watching races. Ellis Park was five miles away from us. When I was a teenager, I was over there all the time. I've always been around it; I've always gambled on it. Sometimes more than I should. I've always enjoyed it."

That indulgence led to the conversation with his wife which opened the door to ownership.

"My wife said I shouldn't gamble so much, just buy one," he said.

He purchased pacing filly Courageous Colors in October 2016. The Net Ten Eom lass didn't race at 2, but made 15 starts as a sophomore. She took her 1:55.3 mark at Hoosier Park in her lone victory. Miller kept the mare and bred her to Riggins, producing Totally Rigged, a mare that has earned \$60,000. She has produced one other winner.

That experience has led to consistent involvement. Miller attends the Hoosier Classic sale each fall looking to purchase one horse. In 2020, luck was on his side when he bought Soaring Now for a mere \$6,000. As a freshman, the JK Endofanera—Sunflower colt won three times and banked \$37,000 for trainer LeWayne Miller. As a sophomore, Aaron Stutzman took over training duties, and Soaring Now scored victories in six of 14 attempts, finishing off the board only three times. The pacer completed the year with \$374,375 in seasonal earnings. He was sold that December.

It would be hard to duplicate those accomplishments and achieve such a tremendous return on investment, but last fall Miller again made a savvy purchase that has already produced exponential returns. Brookview Fancy, cataloged as Hip #278, sold around a third of the way through Hoosier Classic's second session. A JK Endofanera first foal out of \$500,000 winner Get Your Armor, she brought \$13,000, less than half the average price of a 'JK' yearling last year.



"I go up there with a short list and I try to find some value with one," Miller said. "She was it last year. When I looked at her, I went back and looked up her mother. I watched a bunch of her races up at Northfield. She was just a tough mare. I really liked her video. I stand in the back of the walking ring and I watch them circle through that ring. She was already on my list, and I just figured she would bring way out of my league."

But she didn't, and Miller signed the slip and sent her home with Stutzman to train over the winter. Since showing up in a qualifier in early July, Brookview Fancy has been nearly flawless. She finished second in her debut, but has won four-straight since.

"She's big, she's game, and she hasn't done anything wrong from Day One," Stutzman said. "I just think she's come along great. She's a little warm, but other than that, she's just handy. She'll do anything you want to do with her. She doesn't like to sit in a hole, but when she gets out on the front-end rolling, she just keeps on going."

To date, the only bump in the road came in the opening round of Indiana Sires Stakes competition. Set to make her second seasonal start, the filly was scratched after an incident shipping from northern Indiana to Hoosier Park.

"That night we got down there and she had stuck her foot through the trailer window," Stutzman said. "That was an instant scratch. There was blood everywhere. Mostly scrapes and scratches. We were pretty lucky on that deal. I have no idea how she did it. She almost had to sit down to reach up there with her front foot the way she fills out the trailer. She's still got a scar on her ankle from where she tore it up."


Two weeks later, Brookview Fancy was back in action, earning her first win in an overnight event. Steered by Kyle Wilfong, the filly won by more than six lengths as the favorite, pacing the mile in 1:51.4. It is hard for Miller to travel to Hoosier Park and watch the filly race, but he did get to attend for her first sires stakes score. That night she captured a \$68,500 division by a length-and-a-half with Joey Putnam at the lines.

Since that night, the freshman has added two more sires stakes wins. In an Aug. 14 leg she held off Loveyoucookie by a head in 1:52.4. Brookview Fancy and Putnam closed out the month with a one-length triumph in a season's best 1:51.2. The Brookview Farms-bred pacer has raked in \$108,750 and leads the division in points with two legs left before October's Super Final.

Despite the success, Miller doesn't have the best horse in the family at the moment. His father and step-mother own the Stutzman-trained Sabonis, the Indiana-sired sophomore pacer that has won 12 of 13 seasonal starts including nine straight. The Tellitlikeitis colt has banked \$343,250 in 2024.

"I like to give a lot of credit to Aaron and his dad, Levi," Miller said. "They do a heck of a job. They got us started, and they've always been good to us."

# Tyson Jacoby has a knack for hitting the bull's eye

Whether it's on the racetrack, in the rodeo ring, or throwing darts, Tyson Jacoby has a knack for hitting the bull's eye.

Admittedly soft-spoken, the likable standardbred driver certainly has plenty to talk about, good, bad, heartwarming, heartbreaking, and almost everything in between, when it comes to his life and career.

Yet, through it all, Jacoby has always found a way to endure and excel.

"You need to keep your head up," he said. "There will be times in your life when you have to face unexpected things, but it's important to go forward the best you can."

Horses have played an integral role in his life for as long as he can remember.

His father, Gary Woolsey, worked with both thoroughbreds and standardbreds, eventually focusing on the latter.

"My mom and dad were into horses," Jacoby said. "My dad, sister and I moved to Alberta when I was 3. My dad worked with both breeds when there was Northlands Park and Stampede Park in the province.

"One year, I can't quite recall who he was working for at the time, he was making decent money and they wanted him to stay with them. That meant he was moving around a lot, so he went with the standardbreds full time."

Jacoby's friendship with harness racing driver and trainer Mike Hennessy would play a huge role in the former's foray into the sport.

It would also change his life away from the racetrack.

In May 1995, he moved in with the Hennessys.

"When my dad started traveling with standardbreds, Mike's dad, Rod, and his wife at the time, Liz, took me in and adopted me, so I had a steady place to live," Jacoby said. "Basically, I was born and raised on the racetrack."

Jacoby, whose parents both passed away, worked for Rod, who holds status as one of Alberta's all-time top trainers and drivers.

Working for the man who trains and co-owns standouts like Western Canadian preferred superstar pacer Shark Week was an ideal learning environment for the aspiring horseman.

Although it was a difficult decision, Jacoby left the industry for a time at the age of 21 when he welcomed a son.

"I got a factory job and then I got my heavy equipment ticket and Class 1 to operate heavy machinery," he said. "I did a lot of odds and ends types of jobs."

He also earned money, albeit not much, competing at local rodeos.

After he was hurt in the ring, Jacoby, whose long list of injuries includes multiple concussions, a broken neck, broken legs, and broken ankles, reconsidered his future by turning to his past.

"I started riding steers when I was around 12 or 13," he said. "I took a few years off — I got hurt quite a bit — and then I got back into it. I was running short on cash, so I thought to myself, 'I can always get back into horse racing."

So, after a few contemplative moments, he did just that.

It would prove to be a winning move.

Jacob's racing journey has taken him from Ontario to Alberta, and most recently, British Columbia.

He made seven trips to the winner's circle in his rookie 2022 season.

"I was hoping to get 100 drives that first season," he said. "I got my license late, and I left to go work for Casie [Coleman] in Florida, so I ended up with 84 drives. But it started out well and when I came back, I eventually decided to try my luck in B.C. and things ended up taking off once I went out there."

Jacoby recorded 22 victories and \$136,906 in purse earnings last year.

This season, he's on track for a career-best year.

He points to the decision to test out the B.C. racing scene as integral in furthering his career.

"Being in British Columbia has really helped me out," he said. "I have reached all the goals I set for myself last year. Hopefully, I can reach even bigger ones this year.

"When I first got out here, I was fortunate that a lot of people used me to drive for them. That helped a lot. I get along very well with a majority of the horses I drive. I like them all."

Two of his top horses come in the form of Kootenay Cocoa, a 3-year-old pacing daughter of Beren Hanover, and Chasing Bismarck, a 6-year-old pacing son of Mystery Chase.

"I have been able to drive a lot of nice horses out here, one of them being Kootenay Cocoa, who won eight in a row," Jacoby said. "Chasing Bismarck, who was claimed a little while ago, I enjoyed driving him. He is one of a few horses who you can swing three high around the last turn at Fraser Downs and make up ground instead of losing it."

Competing on Canada's West Coast, specifically, the fiveeighths Fraser Downs oval, has also done wonders for Jacoby's confidence.

He's learned, among many things, how to maintain a patient hand in the race bike.

"You don't have to move so early here," he said. "You can wait for that right moment. Obviously, timing is everything in this sport, so learning when to move and when to stay put is important."

After spending most of his summer in Alberta, Jacoby is now back in B.C.

The Fraser Downs fall meet starts on Sept. 12.

It has become a home away from home for the man who once tangled with steers and bulls.

"I drove a horse in a \$100,000 race at Fraser Downs for Donna Cunningham last year," Jacoby said. "I had two driving triples at Fraser Downs, including one last September on my birthday weekend."

Fraser Downs isn't the only track where Jacoby has made a name for himself.

"[High-profile driver and trainer] Kelly Hoerdt called and asked me to drive one in a \$105,000 race this year at Century Downs," Jacoby said. "Being in the \$100,000 race in B.C. and that one in Calgary were amazing to be part of. I didn't win them, but I was in them and part of them. People can see me and you never know what can come of it."

Goals, for the most part, are not grandiose in nature.

"I would like to say I could drive in the North America Cup one day, but I don't know if that would ever happen," he said. "Little goals – those are the ones I focus on.

"I try to set a yearly goal for myself and try to achieve that to the best of my ability. In the long term, I would like to get more drives. I want to drive at Hoosier Park, even if it is just once. I watch that track a lot. It has a beautiful look to it."

Jacoby has an eye-catching look of his own.

His driving colors are an homage to many.

"I got my inspiration for them from [driver] Andrew McCarthy," Jacoby said. "They are his design other than the stars – I went with diamonds. When I was little, I wanted to be a jockey, and my colors were going to be baby blue and purple. But you don't get to pick your own colors with the thoroughbreds.

"I always liked purple. My dad's colors, when he owned horses, were black and green with diamonds. The Hennessys have diamonds too. I ended up going with orange and purple and I think it worked out well."

Although his colors are somewhat flashy, the man who wears them is quite the opposite.

"I am a quiet guy, and I like to stay to myself for the most part," he said.

There is, however, a newfound interest in his life.

Although it doesn't offer the same adrenaline rush as piloting a nearly 1,000-pound racehorse or riding a 1,500-pound bull, it does require an accurate eye and patient hand.

"When I came to BC, I started getting into playing darts," he said. "I enjoy it a lot."

Another welcome opportunity for Jacoby to be right on target.







# Doing it right or not at all are words to live by for Kyle Bossence

If you're going to do something, do it right or don't do it at all.

These are the wise words a young Kyle Bossence first heard from his late grandfather that shaped the now 33-year-old trainer's approach to, as he puts it, "just about everything."

"It's something I've lived by my whole life, no matter what I was doing," Bossence said. "Whether it's been horses, working for other people, farming, excavating, you name it, those words have stuck with me my whole life."

The sage advice has proven invaluable for the well rounded Bossence throughout his eight-year career on the Ontario standardbred circuit.

But like countless others who dedicate their lives to the industry, the native of Arthur, ON, a community of just over 2,600, knows it's all about perspective.

"We take things day-by-day," said Bossence. "I'm a pretty easy going, 'look at the positive side' kind of person as is, which helps. I always look at the upside of every situation and I guess I'm lucky to be wired that way."

Bossence's even-keeled, yet optimistic outlook has been a boon during a 2024 campaign that hasn't matched his expectations following a breakthrough year in 2023.

Last season, Bossence cleared the \$1-million purse-earnings benchmark for the first time after his pupils recorded a 54-50-61 line across 593 starts.

"You just learn to take the good with the bad," he said. "This year's obviously not quite as good as last year was going with 2-year-olds. But you know going in that not every year is going to be as good as others. You have to keep your head up and keep on going."

The arrow is pointing up, however, after a memorable Labor Day Weekend.

There's nothing better than doing something you love with family and friends. [Harness racing has] been a great ride so far, and hopefully, for many more years to come.

On Aug. 30, recent acquisition Cheese Party, a 3-year-old pacing filly whom Bossence purchased in June, crossed the finish line in 1:51.4 to take an Ontario Sires Stakes Prospects Series tilt at Mohawk.

The festivities continued the following day with 11-year-old trotter Willyorwonthe, who scored his second consecutive victory, and 54th overall through 237 starts (54-28-33).

While wins are the name of the game, it was an improbable — at least from what the tote board suggested — effort from battle-tested 3-year-old bay colt Masstercraft (18 3-3-4) that defined the weekend that was.

Under a brilliant trip from driver Trevor Henry, the trotter, at 98-1, finished second in the \$164,000 Simcoe at Mohawk.

"We were really happy with the way he raced last time out at Grand River being parked the whole mile," Bossence said. "And, before that, the win he had in the [OSS Gold] Mid-Season consolation. He got really sick on us after the Good Times there, so we're just happy to see him healthy and win that one.

"Then heading into the Simcoe, we knew he was getting better and better. The only part that we weren't too sure on was drawing the 9-hole. Other than that, we were pretty confident in him going in. I mean, we weren't expecting a win, but we were hoping he could be right there for it."

Those aren't the only protégé's Bossence is bullish about.

The bay trotter he speaks of no doubt has talent, but a stubborn streak can, at times, make it a coin toss as to how she will fare any given night.

"We have Valuable Miss, too," Bossence said, adding with a laugh, "She's a filly who's got a mind of her own. Like [Trevor Henry] says every time he walks over to the bike, 'What kind of a mood is she in tonight?'

"It's hit and a miss with her. We try to do our best to keep her happy but some nights, she's just in one of those moods where she doesn't want to play too much. Other nights, when she is in the right mood, she's pretty tough to beat."

Figuring out horses doesn't begin the moment they enter the Bossence barn for the first time.

When it comes to the sales, it is a combination of homework, a little luck, and embracing the unknown.

The only guarantee when it comes to buying a horse, either for himself or one of his owners?

There are none.

Going into the yearling sales, it's a huge gamble," Bossence said. "It doesn't really matter what pedigree or what you pay for any of them. It doesn't mean the outcome is going to be the same as the horse's family or siblings or anything like that.

"At the sales, I look for traits that I've had luck with in the past. For one thing, I always look for medium, average-sized horses. I don't like them too big and I don't like them too small. So far, I've had the best luck with your average-sized horses. That's what I tend to look for."

Bossence keeps an open mind and open eyes throughout the racing season.

He weighs a number of factors in his assessment of pacers and trotters.

"I try to pay attention to the good horses every year; try to watch them and take note of what they look like and their features, etc." he said. "I know that some years you'll see a horse on the smaller side do well, but on average, it's usually your nice, midsized horses that seem to do the best.

"Obviously, the bigger the horse, the harder on them it's going to be — the more weight they have to carry and the speeds they have to hit nowadays — you have to factor it all in."

The path to developing the next champion racehorse may be winding, and often perplexing, but it always leads Bossence back home.

"My wife, Tamara and I, we've been in this pretty well since the start together," he said. "Our kids are in the barn every day with us, too. My dad [Ron Bossence] works in the summer, but he's here pretty much all winter, and he loves it just as much as I do. He's always there to help as much as he can.

"There's nothing better than doing something you love with family and friends. It's been a great ride so far, and hopefully, for many more years to come."





#### Kihlström hopes for luck with Hail Mary

Örjan Kihlström will hope the third time's the charm when he drives Sweden's Hail Mary in Saturday's \$1 million MGM Yonkers International Trot, but with a challenging starting spot, he readily admitted it might require a bit of good fortune.

Kihlström, who is making his third appearance as a driver in the International Trot, and Hail Mary will leave from post 7 in the 10-horse field, which will go the distance of 1¼ miles on MGM Yonkers Raceway's half-mile oval. Hail Mary, an 8-year-old stallion who was Sweden's Horse of the Year in 2020, is the third choice on the morning line at 9-2.

In the seven editions of the International Trot since its renewal in 2015, the best finish by a horse starting from post 7 has been fifth (twice). All seven winners in the invitational event have started from no farther out than post 6.

"The draw was no good for us, obviously, but you can do nothing about that," said Kihlström, who is a member of Sweden's Trotting Hall of Fame. "We'll try to do our best with it, but it's tough. The horses in this race are all good, so we'll need some luck. But it's the same for all the horses with a bad post. I just hope the

horse has managed the travel well so he can perform as good as he can."

Kihlström has finished fourth in both his previous International Trot appearances despite tricky draws each time. In 2015, he started from post 10 in the second tier with Oasis Bi and in 2016 he left from post 8 with On Track Piraten.

Hail Mary, a son of Googoo Gaagaa—Dreams, heads to the race with 26 wins in 52 career races and \$1.76 million (U.S.) in purses. He has won multiple Group 1 races overseas, including last year's Hugo Abergs Memorial. This year, the Daniel Redén-trained stallion has hit the board five times in nine starts, winning twice. His victories include the Group 2 Jamtlands Stora Pris, which he also captured in 2023.

"I think he's been racing better than it looks," Kihlström said about Hail Mary's current campaign. "He had some bad luck in many of the races. Maybe he hasn't been really as good as last year, but I think he's had some quite good races. He's a good all-around horse. Even though we have a bad post, I think he can do a good race."



Kihlström has won many of the biggest harness races in the world, including four Elitloppets, a Prix d'Amerique, and a Breeders Crown (with Commander Crowe in the 2014 Open Trot at The Meadowlands). In 1990, he appeared in the International Trot as a trainer, sending out Mr Lucken, who finished fifth.

Known as the "Iceman" for his cool demeaner in the sulky, Kihlström followed in family footsteps getting into harness racing. He grew up just a half-mile from Solvalla Racetrack, site of Sweden's Elitloppet, which is one reason his first win in the famed race there with From Above in 2003 ranks as one of his greatest moments.

"I've been watching the Elitloppet ever since I could start walking," Kihlström said in 2022. "I've seen all the great horses and drivers and trainers who came to the Elitloppet and won it. To be one of them myself was just fantastic. It was a horse I'd been driving all the way up, so it couldn't be any bigger than that at that moment."

On Saturday, with a little luck, he could add the International Trot to his résumé.

"I hope so," he said.

Following the International Trot, Hail Mary will remain in the U.S. and head to the stable of trainer Åke Svanstedt, owner Mehdi Yazdanpanh (racing under the Stall Mary AB banner) announced recently on social media.



#### Saunders bullish on Manolete

Manolete is still in the early stages of his career, but trainer Bruce Saunders has already found a lot to like about the freshman male pacer as he prepares to send the colt to his \$150,000 New Jersey Classic final tonight (Sept. 6) at The Meadowlands.

In five starts so far, Manolete has been worse than second only once. He won two preliminary rounds of the New Jersey Sire Stakes series and finished second in the final on Aug. 22 at The Big M, where he lost by a head after being part of an early battle for the lead that resulted in a :53.4 opening half-mile.

Manolete also had a second-place finish in the second leg of the Kindergarten Classic Series at The Meadowlands in early July, when he missed by a neck.

Tonight, he will leave from post 2 with Todd McCarthy in the sulky. He is the 3-1 second choice on the morning line.

"He may be the smartest 2-year-old I've ever been around," Saunders said about Manolete, who is owned by M And L of Delaware and M & M Harness Racing. "I think he's a very flexible and unique horse for a 2-year-old. You can stop and start him. You can use him early, you can use him in the middle, you can use him late. You can race him on the front end, you can race him from behind. I think Todd has a lot of options.

"He's a very good horse, there's no question about that."

Manolete, a son of Cattlewash—Glancewithme, was purchased for \$52,000 at the Standardbred Horse Sale. His family includes Fresh Breeze, the mother of the sport's current No. 1-ranked horse, Twin B Joe Fresh, as well as Grand Circuit winners American Ideal and Make A Success. His fourth dam is Hall of Famer Three Diamonds, the mother of Hall of Famer Life Sign.

After beginning his career with a sixth-place finish in the first leg of the Kindergarten, Manolete has either won or been knocking on the door.

"We're very happy to have a horse of this quality, and a horse that shows up and does his job every week," Saunders said. "We can't ask for more than that."

Manolete has raced only once since July 26. The NJSS championship, originally slated for Aug. 2, was postponed to Aug. 22 because of severe weather and a power outage, and the New Jersey Classic did not require eliminations last week.

"I would have preferred to race last week in eliminations, but he's a very good horse and knows how to take care of himself," Saunders said. "I don't think it really matters how we train him, he comes to work prepared to do his job. I've got complete confidence in him."

Captain Optimistic is the 9-5 morning-line favorite in the New Jersey Classic for 2-year-old male pacers. The son of Captaintreacherous—Cinamony has three wins and a second in four races this season for trainer Nancy Takter and driver Yannick Gingras. He will leave from post 5.

The field also includes Papis Pistol (Papi Rob Hanover—Bang Bang), who upset Captain Optimistic by three-quarters-of-a-length in a conditioned race last week, as well as New Jersey Sire Stakes champ McCusker (Cattlewash—Robocall Hanover) and NJSS third-place finisher Tom Horn (Cattlewash—Dancinwiththestarz).

"As we've watched many times in a horse race, anything can happen, but I'm very confident in my horse," Saunders said. "I think they're all pretty much good horses, but I wouldn't trade Manolete for any 2-year-old on any night that I've seen yet. It's going to be an exciting race. I just hope for the same amount of racing luck that everybody else has. No more, no less."

The New Jersey Classic for freshman male pacers is one of eight finals for 2- and 3-year-old pacers and trotters tonight at The Meadowlands. The finals for pacers go for \$150,000 and the finals for trotters go for \$250,000.

My Sweet Lily (Sweet Lou-Mimi's Lily) is the 5-2 favorite in the final for 2-year-old female pacers while Rocket Deo (Captaintreacherous—Rocklamation) gets the 4-5 nod among 3-year-old female pacers and Wish You Well (Bettor's Wish—Where's Alice) is the 8-5 choice among 3-year-old male pacers.

Hambletonian Oaks winner Warrawee Michelle (Walner—Sound Check) is the 6-5 favorite in the Classic for 3-year-old female trotters while Earl Beal Memorial champ Sig Sauer (Muscle Hill—Sigilwig) is the 4-5 fave among the sophomore boys. Lady Landia (Tactical Landing—Seventimesalady) is the 2-1 favorite for 2-year-old female trotters and Hidalgo (Muscle Hill—Brooklyn) is the 2-1 choice among the freshman male trotters.

#### Louprint outfoots Sippinonsearoc, Luna Lovegood demonstrates class at The Red Mile

On Tuesday (Sept. 3) **Louprint** illustrated he is one to watch as did **Luna Lovegood** with their triumphs in the \$80,000 fourth legs of the Kentucky Sire Stakes Championship Series in their respective divisions for 2-year-old male pacers and freshman trotting fillies at The Red Mile.

Louprint (Ronnie Wrenn, Jr.) was the first to place his hooves upon the red clay and came along the outside to score over American Son (Dexter Dunn) by a neck in a new lifetime best of 1:49. Sippinonsearoc (Yannick Gingras), the fastest 2-year-old pacer in harness racing history, was third.

The son of Sweet Lou—Rockin Racer commenced his mile from the rail. He and his reinsman settled in fourth position in the field of six leaving the gate. Stablemate Sippinonsearoc went right to the top and posted fractions of :28, :55 and 1:22. Shipmaster (Todd McCarthy) was right behind the world champion with American Son in third and Louprint remaining in fourth.

When the field rounded the final bend Sippinonsearoc's early efforts took some starch out of him, as American Son and Louprint saved their best for last.

In a stirring final drive to the line, Louprint battled with American Son and a game Sippinonsearoc. It was Louprint's :26.1 final panel that enabled him to enter the winner's enclosure.

Trained by Ron Burke, Louprint improved his record to 6 5-1-0 and boosted his bank account to \$159,864. The colt's only defeat is behind Sippinonsearoc by a neck in the first leg of this series.

Louprint now holds the advantage as he has defeated Sippinonsearoc in their last two engagements.

Bred by his trainer's racing stable, Weaver Bruscemi and Phillip Collura, the colt competes as a homebred for his connections.

Louprint provided his supporters with \$3.14 for his victory, which is his third straight.

Luna Lovegood (Dunn) collected her second consecutive win with a smart steer by her pilot. The daughter of Gimpanzee—Southwind Venus was able to hold off the late charge by R

Dutchess (Jody Jamieson) in the lane to stop the clock in 1:53. Torrisi (Gingras) snatched the show spot.

Luna Lovegood began trotting from post position 5 in the field of nine. Gingras placed his charge immediately on the front as the eventual winner was in third. Torrisi clicked off splits of :29.4, :57.2 and 1:26 with first leg winner Yo Tillie in second.

Dunn and his pupil made their move entering the stretch. Luna Lovegood simply had more trot than R Dutchess, who closed from fifth, and the previous two leaders. The filly came home in :26.3.

Conditioned by Marcus Melander, Luna Lovegood's resume now stands at 4 3-0-0 and she has earned \$120,000 in purse money.

The filly was bred by Blue Chip Farms and Stefan Melander. She was a \$100,000 purchase at the 2023 Standardbred Horse Sale under the name Witness Blue Chip by Holly Lane Stud East.

Luna Lovegood paid \$6.42 to win as the public's second selection.

## GINGRAS, TAKTER TAKE TWO COMMONWEALTH SERIES EVENTS WITH REGALLY BRED YOUNGSTERS

**Fusion** and Gingras won by a neck in 1:50.4 in the \$30,000 fourth leg of the Kentucky Commonwealth Series for 2-year-old male pacers as the heavy favorite. Higher Ground (Andy Miller) was second and Bourbon County (T. McCarthy) was third.

The son of racing royalty in Horse of the Year Always B Miki and multiple Dan Patch Award winner, Pure Country was the heavy favorite and improved his career slate to 4-3-1. The colt has amassed \$52,500.

The only blemish on his record is a loss to American Son in the second leg of this series. American Son gave Louprint all he could handle with a world champion behind him in third.

Trained by Nancy Takter, Fusion, races for his breeding operation's (Diamond Creek Farm) racing contingent.

The colt is the third foal out of a world champion and dual Breeders Crown winning dam, who earned \$2.43 million in

her prolific career. Pure Country was the first female pacer to win divisional honors at 2, 3 and 4.

Fusion paid \$2.14 for the victory.

Deja Blu (Gingras) also has regal blood rolling through her veins. The daughter of Horse of the Year Muscle Hill and 2018 Hambletonian winner, Atlanta, established a new lifetime mark of 1:53 and collected her third consecutive victory in the fourth leg of the Commonwealth Series for freshman trotting fillies. Winnpanzee (T. McCarthy) was second and Esme (Tim Tetrick) was third.

Also trained by Takter, Deja Blu was bred by Crawford Farms Racing, Bradley Grant and Howard Taylor. The filly is owned by Crawford Farms Racing and Thomas Pontone.

Deja Blu is now 5 3-0-0 and possesses a bankroll of \$51,400. The filly paid \$2.60 to win.

Unlike her colleagues, Kadena, a daughter of Muscle Hill and Dan Patch Award winner Mission Brief did not have her picture taken. The filly and driver Dexter Dunn were second to Swoop (T. Tetrick) in the second division of the fourth leq

of the Commonwealth Series for 2-year-old trotting fillies. Voguish (Gingras) was third.

By Walner and out of Batoutahill, Swoop broke her maiden in her fifth lifetime start, so the final time of 1:54.4 is her new mark.

Swoop is the fourth foal out of her dam who broke the \$100,000 as a race mare. The filly is a half-sibling to Bargain (Chapter Seven, \$268,805) and was an \$80,000 selection at the 2023 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale.

She was bred Steve Stewart and Michael Andrew and is owned by Harbor Racing Stable, Walling Racing Stable, Joe Sbrocco & JAF Racing and Van Camp Trotting Corp.

Swoop paid \$32.06 for her first win after going off at 15-1.

Racing continues on the same Sunday, Monday, Tuesday schedule at The Red Mile on Sept. 8, 9 and 10. First post is 5:05 p.m. on Sunday and at 1 p.m. on Monday and Tuesday.

The lucrative Kentucky Sire Stakes Championship finals will be conducted on Sunday (Sept. 15).

# Ponda Fashion, Graber, Jr. trainees score in Indiana Sire Stakes

The path to victory was clear in round five of Indiana Sire Stakes for 2-year-old trotting fillies Tuesday (Sept. 3) at Harrah's Hoosier Park, with the pocket-sitter prevailing in all three divisions. **Ponda Fashion** and **Classical Jane** each scored upsets at double-digit odds, while **Better Tak'em** was the lone favorite to take home her \$45,500 split.

Ponda Fashion was sent away at 11-1 from post 6 in the field of seven with regular pilot Kyle Wilfong in tow for the first division.

Wilfong hustled Ponda Fashion towards the front early, grabbing good position in the pocket behind 1-5 favorite Miracle Maven

(driven by John De Long) through a quarter of :28.1. The field remained single-file to the half in :57.3 before the lead duo began to open up on the final turn, trotting well clear through three-quarters in 1:27.1.

Turning for home, De Long began to go to work on Miracle Maven with Wilfong yet to move Ponda Fashion off his helmet midway through the lane. Wilfong waited for the passing lane to open up before timing his move perfectly with Ponda Fashion, rocketing home in :27.3 to reach the wire a half-length in front of Miracle Maven in 1:55.1. Bluebird Lola (Trace Tetrick) finished third, four lengths back of the winner.

Ponda Fashion (Kyle Wilfong) winning her Indiana Sire Stakes test for 2-year-old trotting fillies on Tuesday at Harrah's Hoosier Park.



The clocking was a lifetime best for the Jay Hochstetler trained daughter of Crescent Fashion out of the Big Stick Lindy mare, Ponda's Lucky Lady. The half-sister to Harrah's Hoosier Park track-record holder and Hochstetler stablemate, Ponda Jet, has won three of six on the season. Bred by Pond-A-Acres, the earner of \$66,700 is owned by Connie and Homer Hochstetler, Robert Buddig and Allen Schwartz.

Driver Jordan Ross teamed up with trainer Henry Graber, Jr. to snag the final two Sire Stakes divisions on the card, the first coming with 3-5 favorite Better Tak'em in the second split.

Leaving from post 6, Ross inherited the lead going into the first turn after M-M's Charm (Pete Wrenn) jumped it off during a leave attempt, guiding the fillies to the quarter in :28.3. Woodside Izz (LeWayne Miller) passed on finding a seat on the first turn and took command of the field on the backstretch, leading the fillies to the half in :58. Due to a trio of early breakers, there were four fillies left in contention on the far turn with Woodside Izz leading the charge to three-quarters in 1:28.2.

Better Tak'em popped the pocket turning for home, quickly assuming command from Woodside Izz. Trotting home in :27.4, Better Tak'em trotted confidently to a 2¾-length victory over Woodside Izz in 1:56.2. GV Miss Stephen (James Yoder) crossed the wire third, eight lengths back at 82-1.

Through six starts, Better Tak'em is yet to finish worse than second with three victories and three runner-up finishes. Owned by Henry Graber, Jr. and Elven Star Stables, the \$15,000 yearling buy at the Hoosier Classic has banked \$107,625. Steven Mast bred the daughter from the first crop of Don't Let'em out of the Cantab Hall mare, Barmaid.

The Ross/Graber, Jr. combo delivered much better value for the bettors with their second stakes score when Classical Jane got up at 11-1 in the third and final division.

Classical Jane made quick work of the outside post 7, crossing over to the pylons in front through a quarter of :28.3. Trace Tetrick sent 2-5 favorite Swan Jewel to the lead from third on the backstretch, giving the pocket ride to Classical Jane to the half in :58.2. Swan Jewel had things her way on the far turn, reaching the three-quarter pole first in 1:27.4.

Tipping from the pocket at the top of the stretch, Classical Jane quickly pulled alongside Swan Jewel to grab a short lead with an eighth-of-a-mile to go. From there, Classical Jane wore down Swan Jewel to trot clear by 1¼ lengths over the favorite on the wire in 1:56.4. Sweetasmoni (Wilfong) rallied for the show spot.

After breaking her maiden in leg 4 of Indiana Sire Stakes at 22-1 in her last outing, the win was the second in seven career outings for Classical Jane. The daughter of Swan For All—Class Angel is owned by Eleven Star Stables, Frank Baldachino, Beasty LLC and Backroad Stables. Steve Mast bred Classical Jane who sports earnings of \$62,655.

Five \$20,000 divisions for the fourth leg of the Buckeye Stallion Series for 2-year-old colt pacers highlighted the Tuesday evening (Sept. 4) card at MGM Northfield Park. **Go Jim Dandy** not only produced the fastest division of the night but blocked previously perfect Jbmagic from a fourth series win.

Go Jim Dandy and Hunter Myers refused to be anywhere but the lead. The gelded son of Bit Of A Legend N grabbed the front directly out of the gate. As soon as the dust settled, 3-5 favorite Jbmagic (Austin Hanners) challenged at the :27.2 opening quarter. Go Jim Dandy immediately popped the pocket to regain control before reaching the half in :56.2. His competitors were relentless as second choice 3-1 Johnny Up (Chris Lems) marched first up on the backside. It wasn't long before 9-2 Go Jim Dandy hit another gear and pulled away from the field while heading to the three-quarters in 1:24.2. Under confident hands, Go Jim Dandy cruised home in 1:54.3 with eight lengths to spare.

Rose Run Ajay (Anthony MacDonald) finished second and Jbmagic held on for third.

Go Jim Dandy has hit the board in six of eight lifetime starts. With two series victories, the gelding has bankrolled \$29,144 for trainer/owner Kim Dailey and Jr Staple Llp. Go Jim Dandy is a homebred named in remembrance of Dailey's late husband and Ohio Immortal Hall of Fame trainer, James Dailey.

The first division was taken by **Fear The Thunder** in 1:57.2. Driven by Tyler Angus, 9-5 favorite Fear The Thunder won in true wire-to-wire fashion. The colt by Fear The Dragon set fractions in :28.4, :59.3 and 1:28.3 before stopping the clock in a new lifetime mark.

Mama Said Zip It (Hanners) was second while Herbie's Rocket (Lems) finished third.

The victory marks the second series win for Fear The Thunder. He is seven of 10 this season, earning \$34,670 for owners William Beacham and Robert Robinson. Stacey Currie trains Fear The Thunder who was bred by Winbak Farm.

Accuracy By Volume notched his first Buckeye Stallion Series victory in the second division. Aaron Merriman settled 2-5 favorite Accuracy By Volume into the pocket behind Billion (Kurt Sugg). Accuracy By Volume stayed patient as the

quarters passed in :28.1,:58.2, and 1:26.3. The son of Lost In Time made his move at the top of the stretch. Pulling to the outside, Accuracy By Volume easily tripped the wire in 1:55.1.

Billion held on for second with Southern Rockfest (Hanners) in third.

Despite being lightly started compared to his peers, Accuracy By Volume has won three of his four lifetime starts. Trained by Scott Betts, the colt has earned \$20,080. Timothy Betts bred and owns Accuracy By Volume.

The third division was won by **The Onyx Dragon** and Justin Irvine in 1:55. The gelded son of Fear The Dragon got away third as Downbytheparade (Merriman) posted the opening fraction in :27.4. At 2-1, The Onyx Dragon pulled first up as they passed the half-mile marker in :57.3. Irvine urged the gelding passing the 1:25.4 three-quarter pole. Answering the call, The Onyx Dragon overtook the field to win in his final strides.

Downbytheparade was second and Itwasaverygoodyear (Tyler Smith) finished third.

Gary Martin conditions The Onyx Dragon. With \$37,646 in the bank, he has hit the board eight of nine lifetime starts. It was the first series win for the gelding in a new lifetime mark. Sue Stockwell owns The Onyx Dragon who was bred by Brent Hopper.

**Believe In Tom** was the longshot winner of the night in the fourth division. At 13-1, Believe In Tom and MacDonald cleared the front and never faltered. Sired by the successful trotter Long Tom, the pacer Believe In Tom opened up to set fractions in 28.1, :58.1, and 1:26.1. Never facing any challengers, Believe In Tom scored in 1:55.2.

Scares Me (Myers) finished second while Seaside Star (Sugg) was third.

Believe In Tom has taken two series legs with earnings of \$36,213 in 11 starts and has secured five wins under Steve Novak's training. Believe In Tom is owned and bred by Gerald Mijal.

Buckeye Stallion Series action continues with freshmen filly pacers tonight (Sept. 6) at Eldorado Scioto Downs. First race post is 5:45 p.m.

## LBJ Wall of Fame to welcome Yannick Gingras

Yannick Gingras, a three-time Little Brown Jug winning driver, has been selected as the 39th Little Brown Jug Wall of Fame honoree by the Delaware County Fair.

The third-generation horseman and native of Quebec began jogging horses at the age of 5, training at 10 and driving at 18 years of age. He moved to the United States in 2001 and he has never looked back.

Gingras has won more than 9,000 career races and \$238 million in earnings to rank fourth on the all-time list.

Gingras first hoisted the Little Brown Jug in 2014 with Limelight Beach, in 2017 behind Filibuster Hanover and finally in 2021 with Lou's Pearlman.

He has turned the Delaware County Fair half-mile track into his personal playground. Along with his three Jug wins, Gingras has a Jugette hat trick, and has captured the Old Oaken Bucket four times, as well as the Buckette and 15 divisions of the Standardbred.

Gingras is a two-time Dan Patch Driver of the Year (2014 and 2017) and led the sport in earnings five times (2014-2017 and 2023).

He achieved the sport's greatest honor when he was inducted into the Harness Racing Hall of Fame in 2022.

Gingras will be honored the Tuesday evening (Sept. 17) before the 79th edition of the \$800,000 (est.) Little Brown Jug and in the winner's circle on Jug Day (Sept. 19).

# The \$320G Stallion Series finals Sunday at Philly

Harrah's Philadelphia is proud to be hosting the \$320,000 Pennsylvania Stallion Series Championships on its 12:40 p.m. card on Sunday (Sept. 8). There are eight \$40,000 Championships, with a final for each gait, sex, and age combination.

The Stallion Series was designed for horses who might not be of the absolute top quality to contest the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes, one of the strongest programs in North America, giving these talented trotters and pacers a chance to compete for quality money. And talent they do possess: the fastest miles ever in the program's Championships (all three of Pennsylvania's harness tracks, which rotate hosting on the state-sired finales, are five-eighths-mile tracks) are 1:50 on the pace (Flash Move, 2023) and 1:53 on the trot (Rossini, 2013). It would not be surprising to see these standards threatened Sunday at Philly, such have been the clockings put up at the southeast Pennsylvania oval this year.

Often the Stallion Series can be a springboard to future success at higher levels: the pacing filly Weeper won her 2-year-old Stallion Series Championship in 2013, then stepped up her game and triumphed in the 2014 Sire Stakes Championship. This year, the two fillies who won their Stallion Series Championships at 2, trotter Sambuca Hanover and pacer Miki In Luv, will be trying to duplicate Weeper, racing for \$252,000 in their Sire Stakes Championships Monday at Pocono. This progression is part of the reason why only one 2-year-old winner from each division has come back and won their Championship at 3 over the 14 years of the Stallion Series program.

And there can be another type of progression in the Stallion Series – Ante Up Hanover, the Fair Sire Stakes champion at 2 for pacing males, this year came in second in his Stallion Series sophomore division point standings, and he'll be among the highly regarded ones in his Sunday race at Philly.

No one won in all four of the Stallion Series preliminaries. A few horses started three times in the Stallion Series and won them all, and one of the main matchups on Sunday will be in the fifth race StS Championship for freshman trotting males, where prelim point leader Scudo Hanover, who won three times, faces off against Hey Porter, who was victorious in all three of his starts at this level.

Being leading point winner indicates talent, of course, but it is no sign of imminent success: the pacing colt freshman division and the trotting filly sophomore section have produced only one Champion who led their group in the preliminary point standings over the length of the program.

The Stallion Series serves an important function in the Pennsylvania breeding and racing industry, and they are often entertaining puzzlers for the fans to figure out and wager on – and eight new Stallion Series Champions will be crowned on Sunday at Harrah's Philadelphia. ## Top drivers return to H3R for Super Sunday

Two world class harness racing drivers, Louis-Philippe Roy and Daniel Dube are returning to their home province of Quebec for Super Sunday (Sept. 8), to compete in the \$500,000 Quebec Championship finals at the Hippodrome 3R.

The 12-race card that begins at noon features eight championship finals. Four of the finals of the Breeders Trophy Series for 3-year-olds with each division for trotters and pacers going for a purse of \$65,000. Plus, four finals of the Future Stars Series for 2-year-olds trotters and pacers, each racing for a purse of \$55,000.

It is the richest day of horse racing in all of Quebec.

Roy, a three-time O'Brien award winner, has drives in 10 of the 12 races, seven of those races, all finals, he will be driving horses that he has bred and owns. They are Ronda Du Lac (post 6) in race 7 and Olaf Du Lac (post 5) in the 10th race.

What does Roy look forward to most in returning to Quebec for the finals?

"Seeing people happy after all the work they put into their horses and enjoying success in the finals," Roy said. "A lot of people in Quebec are owners and breeders, and sometimes even trainers as well of their horses, so it's what they've been aiming for, for years."

Dube, born and raised in Trois-Rivieres, has been a leading driver wherever he has competed and is closing in on his 10,000th career win. He has more than \$137 million in purse earnings. Dube has drives in seven of the 12 races on the card, four of them in the finals.

Dube was also the driver of the fastest mile ever at H3R, 1:49.1, set by This Is The Plan in winning the 2019 \$200,000 Prix d'Ete.

Also, returning home to Quebec from the USA for Super Sunday is driver Simon Allard, who has four drives on the program, all for his father, trainer/owner/breeder Michel Allard.

Standouts in the finals include the only horse Sunday who has a chance to sweep all three preliminary legs and the final in Boomboom Tonight (post 2) in the 10th race 3-year-old colt pace final. He has won four of his last five starts for driver Pascal Berube and owner/trainer/breeder Elisabeth Pothier.

Vermont resident and award-winning taxidermist Cathy Gearwar won a non winners pace with her own **Trineville**, fresh off a show finish in the New York Fair finals at Goshen on Sept. 1 and Nelson Haley drove Michael Tambollio's **Southern Winds** to win a pacing event in 2:03. John Gerow got his first career win in the free for all trot in 2:04.3 with **Lightningfast**, trained and owned by Wil Dubois of Cambridge, NY.
