# Remembering Peter Haughton and Jim Doherty

## HOLLYWOOD'S HITS

The 44th Peter Haughton Memorial will be contested tonight (Sept. 13) at Hoosier Park. This is the second year that the race – along with the Jim Doherty Memorial – will be contested in Indiana (Soiree Hanover and T C I won in 2023). Both races debuted in New Jersey at The Meadowlands with the fillies going first in 1977 in what was then known as the Merrie Annabelle – renamed to the Doherty in 2015 – and the colts starting the year after Haughton’s passing in 1981.

Here’s a closer look at Haughton who would have turned 70 just nine days after his race in 2024.

### BY THE NUMBERS

Peter Haughton was born on 9/22/54.

He won his first race with Dr. Dewars in a PASS with his mom Dot as his caretaker on June 22, 1971.

He became a \$100G race winner twice as a teenager in 1974 the first with Armbro Omaha.

He became the youngest ever winner of any Triple Crown race in 1976 winning the Kentucky Futurity at age 22, with Quick Pay.

He became the youngest ever winner of the Roosevelt International in 1978 and 1979 in his only two appearances with Cold Comfort and Doublemint at age 23 and 24, respectively.

He won 571 races and \$6,417,862 at the time of his car accident outside The Meadowlands on Jan. 25, 1980.

He had four siblings that he left behind: Holley, Cammie, Billy, Jr. and Tommy.

## THE MAN

Peter was making a name for himself and never wanted to be known as the boss' son. His father, Billy, knew all about the expectations for anyone trying to follow his lead. Pete Axthelm said of Peter, "He had a vibrant presence. There was room in his broad spirit for all sorts of enjoyable facets."

Peter paid his dues; he insisted on it.

When Peter passed away Stanley Dancer said, "This should have been the greatest beginning not the summation. This memorial [a wing built at the Hall of Fame honoring Peter's memory] is a memorial to all that is good in harness racing." (Three hundred turned out in June 1980 for the dedication).

Axthelm summed up the four reasons for Peter's success, "He had keen intelligence, good reflexes, built-in horsemanship, and a total obsession with the sport."

## THE MEMORIAL RACE(S)

Nobody else in harness history can say the following: They had two races named for them, one on each gait, and both valued at over \$500G.

From 1981-84 Roosevelt Raceway had a Peter Haughton Memorial for freshman pacers that carried pots of \$512,000, \$510,400, \$559,800, and \$611,800, respectively.

In 1981, The Meadowlands held the Peter Haughton Memorial Trot in three divisions and his brother Tommy won one with Triplemint. From 1982 on, the race became the richest 2YOCT anywhere, actually reaching \$1 million in 1984 and 1985. Thirteen times the race surpassed a half million dollars.

## HIS LEGACY

His life was cut short at 25. Was he "The Chosen One?" In many ways, yes. But you then have to live up to that. He more than accomplished that.

At Peter's funeral, Axthelm summed it up best, "Peter has a place in our consciousness, our memory, and our richly-won respect."

## THE JIM DOHERTY MEMORIAL

The companion event takes place two weeks to the day of what would have been Doherty's 84th birthday.

Standout winners include Delmegan (1980), Winky's Gill (1982), Davidia Hanover (1984), Britelite Lobell (1985), Peace Corps (1988), CR Kay Suzie (1994), Spellbound Hanover (2000), Shake It Cerry (2013), and Mission Brief (2014).

Doherty's career saw him with a pair of truly outstanding trotters, No Nonsense Woman and \$3 million earner Fools Goal.

Doherty also campaigned the only female to win 16 races in a single Meadowlands meet, Green With Envy in 1984.

He entered the Hall of Fame in 2002 alongside Berndt Lindstedt and Bob McIntosh.

## ETCETERA

Guess who won the very first Merrie Annabelle in 1977 at The Meadowlands with a filly named Rosemary? You guessed it, Peter Haughton.

# Maryland favored in Hoosier's Peter Haughton Memorial

More often than not, Anders Ström's Courant Inc. is the sole owner of the yearlings he buys. But when it came to 2-year-old male trotter Maryland, Ström decided the more, the merrier.

And after watching the Marcus Melander-trained Maryland romp to victory in the \$425,500 William Wellwood Memorial last month at Woodbine Mohawk Park, the colt's ownership group has ample reason to feel good as Maryland heads to tonight's (Sept. 13) \$390,000 Peter Haughton Memorial for freshman male trotters at Harrah's Hoosier Park.

Courant Inc. purchased Maryland, then named Charlie K Hanover, for \$475,000 at last fall's Lexington Selected Yearling Sale. The colt's price was fourth highest for the

sale, and second among male trotters. Ström then had Peter Weisberg's PCW Racing, the Melander family's Holly Lane Stud East, Steve Stewart, and Robin Thorn join him in ownership.

"With Maryland, Anders was really high on him and wanted to have some of his closest friends involved with the horse," Weisberg said. "So, he made an exception to his rule of usually owning them by himself to involve some of his good friends."

Maryland is a son of Chapter Seven and the first foal out of the stakes-winning mare Crucial. His family includes Venerable, who was a Dan Patch and O'Brien awards winner as a 2-year-old in 2021. Ström and Courant's Swedish-based trainer/racing manager Sabine

Kagebrandt were unable to attend the Lexington sale, but worked together with Melander to identify horses, which also resulted in buying Meshuggah, who won the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes championship for 2-year-old male trotters earlier this month.

“He’s beautifully gaited and such a smart horse,” Melander said about Maryland, who was originally named after Charlie Keller but renamed Maryland to honor the location of the Keller family’s Yankeeland Farms while reflecting Ström’s alphabetical system for naming his horses, which for foals of 2022 was M. “He’s got the right attitude; he wants to do it. He just behaves like a good horse. He’s done most things right so far in his career.”

Maryland has hit the board in four of five races this season, winning two and earning \$230,378. He opened his career with a 1:56.4 victory, with a :26.2 last quarter, in the first round of the Kindergarten Classic Series at The Meadowlands. After going off-stride on a sloppy track in his next start, he finished second in the third leg of the Kindergarten.

He then was off to Canada for the Wellwood, where he was fourth-placed-third in his elimination before winning the final from post 9 by 4¾ lengths over even-money favorite Nordic Catcher S in 1:53.4. Maryland’s time equaled the second fastest in the history of the event.

Tonight, he will head to the Peter Haughton Memorial as the 2-1 morning-line favorite. He will start from post 8 with driver Dexter Dunn.

“He can leave like a rocket if he has to,” said Weisberg, who noted two-time Haughton winner Mickey McNichol is a big fan

of the horse. “He drew outside [in the Wellwood] and before you could count to three, he was on top. He beat some pretty good horses and Dexter never even pulled the ear plugs or lifted the lines. He looks like he’s a little bit of a scary horse. He’s got to continue to do it, but he’s a wonderful horse, a talented horse.

“The way Marcus has trained the horse has been, in my opinion, exceptional. Each start he’s brought this horse down a notch. You don’t see it like that all the time. I can’t say enough about Marcus and his team, including caretaker Amalie Ødegård.”

Melander won the 2022 Haughton with Courant-owned Kilmister. Courant also won the race in 2014 with Centurion ATM in partnership with Knutsson Trotting.

Father TJ, coming off a third-place finish in the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes final, is the 3-1 second choice in the Haughton. The son of Father Patrick—Dip Me Hanover will leave from post 5 with Tyler Buter driving for trainer Jeff Cullipher.

As has been the case in recent years, the Haughton and companion Jim Doherty Memorial for 2-year-old female trotters will offer “Win and You’re In” status for the 2024 Breeders Crown. The official winner of each race, if Breeders Crown eligible as of June 1, will advance directly to their respective final, with no starting fee, and the opportunity to draw for post 1 through 5.

Melander will send out two fillies in the \$305,000 Doherty. Royal Mission, who won the New York Sire Stakes championship last week, will start from post 9 with driver Scott Zeron and is 5-1 on the morning line. The daughter of Chapter Seven—Swinging Royalty has hit the board in six of seven races for owner Jeff Snyder, winning three and banking \$252,801.

Italian-bred Goodgirl Bi, Melander’s other horse, will leave from post 1 with Mattias Melander in the sulky. She has hit the board in three of four races, including a win in a division of the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes. The daughter of Greenshoe—Princess Grif, owned by Courant, was sixth from post 8 in the final at Hollywood Casino at The Meadows, where she was beaten only three-quarters-of-a-length for third after being involved in a :26.3 opening quarter.

“Royal Mission has been racing good,” said Melander, who won the 2019 Doherty with Courant’s Hypnotic AM. “She drew a little bad, so we’ll need a little luck, but she’s a nice filly. She can leave, she can race from behind, she’s handled every size track. She likes her work and is easy to drive.

“Goodgirl’ could have been third instead of being sixth in the PA final, she just got a little tired the last couple of steps there. She’s been really good all year. She drew better now, so we’ll see if she can pick up something from there. There are some nice horses in there, but she’s OK herself.”

New Jersey Sire Stakes champion Champagne Problems is the 2-1 morning-line favorite in the Doherty. The daughter of Tactical Landing—Miss Caviar will leave from post 7 with Dunn driving for trainer Nancy Takter.

## Fields drawn for Peter Haughton, Jim Doherty Memorials at Harrah's Hoosier Park

Tonight (Sept. 13), Harrah's Hoosier Park will play host to two of the premier stakes in North America for 2-year-old trotters for the second-straight year with the Peter Haughton and Jim Doherty Memorials. Two full fields of 10 will go postward in each race, with a number of local competitors looking to protect the home-track advantage.

The \$390,000 Peter Haughton Memorial for 2-year-old trotting colts serves as the 10th race on the evening, headlined by the only once beaten Eugene The Genius from the Missy Essig barn. The Indiana-bred gelded son of Helpisontheway—Muscle Baby Doll enters off of a career best effort in his last outing, a 5¼-length romp in 1:54 to take leg 5 of the Indiana Sire Stakes. Leaving from post 6 with regular pilot Mike Oosting listed to drive, Eugene The Genius has won six of seven in his rookie campaign while banking \$155,625 for owners Russ Beeman and Charles Weaver.

Eugene The Genius will hook up with Maryland who heads to Indiana fresh off a 17-1 romp in the \$425,500 William Wellwood at Woodbine Mohawk Park in his last outing on Aug. 24. The two-time winning son of Chapter Seven—Crucial leaves

from post 8 for the red-hot Marcus Melander barn with Dexter Dunn listed to drive the earner of \$230,378.

The 10 hopefuls look to follow in the footsteps of T C I who won the 2023 Peter Haughton Memorial in the first year it was held at Harrah's Hoosier Park. T C I took the 2023 edition in front-end fashion in 1:54.2 in a campaign which saw him bank over \$1.2 million and take O'Brien Award honors.

In the \$305,000 Jim Doherty Memorial for trotting fillies, Ponda Fashion gives trainer Jay Hochstetler the opportunity to do one better than last year's runner-up finish with Ponda Title to eventual Dan Patch Award winner, Soiree Hanover. A winner in her last outing, Ponda Fashion was victorious in leg five of Indiana Sire Stakes in a lifetime best of 1:55.1, getting by the heavily favored Miracle Maven to do so. Ponda Fashion has won half of her six outings on the year, each with driver Kyle Wilfong in the bike. The daughter of Crescent Fashion—Ponda's Lucky Lady is a half-sister to Harrah's Hoosier Park track record holder and fellow Hochstetler stable star, Ponda Jet. Ponda Fashion will leave from post 3 tonight.

The Hoosier standout will have a pair of Sire Stakes champions from the northeast to deal with if she wants to get to the winner's circle. New Jersey Sire Stakes champion, Champagne Problems, leaves from post 7 from the Nancy Takter barn. A winner in three of six as well, the daughter of Tactical Landing—Miss Caviar has banked \$175,004 on the year and enters the Doherty off of a fourth-place finish in the \$288,600 Peaceful Way final at Mohawk.

New York Sire Stakes champion Royal Mission will have to overcome the far outside post 9 tonight. Trainer Marcus Melander sends the daughter of Chapter Seven—Swinging Royalty to Hoosier Park six days after claiming the \$225,000 NYSS final at Yonkers in the rain in 1:58.2. Already with a quarter-million dollars made, Royal Mission has won three times and hit the board in six of seven to begin her young career. Melander trainees will bookend the gate, with Goodgirl Bi IT leaving from the rail.

The Jim Doherty will serve as the 12th race on the card.

## Western Fair back on track for fall meet

*London's popular half-mile track will open its meet on Oct. 1 after a complete overhaul of the track surface. Also, the Homestretch Bar will reopen and a large infield video board is also on the way.*

When The Raceway at Western Fair District concluded its successful spring meet on May 31, those in charge of London, ON's cherished half-mile oval wasted no time shifting gears to the return of live racing on Oct. 1.

With just 123 days between the spring and fall seasons, and several ambitious projects on the docket – including a complete resurfacing of the track itself – time was of the essence.

But as Greg Blanchard, director of equine programming at Western Fair reminded, it will all be worth it come opening night.

“It was something that was a little bit overdue,” said Blanchard. “We teamed up with a local construction company and had some consultation to go along with that.

“Everything went smoothly and on schedule. It's been completed and we expect good things when we return in the fall.”

Alongside cleaner turns, sharper straightaways and an overall uptick in class, Blanchard said the track's rejuvenation will be particularly valuable as the temperature begins to drop.

“Digging down into the base and redoing that portion of the track gives us better drainage, which should help us through the winter months,” said Blanchard. “That should give us a more consistent racing surface to maintain.

“We’ve got an amazing track crew here, and you have to be one of the best in the business to deal with the type of surface we have and the weather conditions that we deal with.”

While horses and horsepeople are enjoying the new playing surface, fans will have access to another view of the action courtesy of a brand-new videoboard coming to the infield.

The single, larger screen will replace the existing dual monitor setup that Blanchard said had been in place for a little over 10 years.

“We’re hoping it’ll be ready for the start of racing, but if not, it should be ready very early into the season,” said Blanchard. “And we’ll be able to move it in and replace the existing videoboards that we have.

“It serves as an additional viewing option for folks that are outside or up in the restaurant watching. But it also serves as our big tote board as well. It’s a very important thing, especially for that on track experience, and for folks that are wanting to watch in person.”

For all the major upgrades happening inside the field of play, it is the long-awaited reopening of a fan favorite hangout that has Blanchard and company teeming with anticipation.

During the height of the COVID-19 pandemic, Western Fair’s first floor space, which features the site’s renowned Homestretch Bar, was converted into London’s primary vaccination center.

Beginning this fall, it will once again be open to customers.

“We’re really looking forward to that,” said Blanchard, who praised Western Fair’s patrons for their patience. “That might be the most exciting thing for us, frankly.”

Blanchard also noted that the Western Fair team used the summer to make some “cosmetic changes” on the first floor.

“Our old simulcast area that had individual betting carrels was a dark, sort of private space,” said Blanchard. “It’s a brighter, more open space now. Everything’s going to be really inviting – we’ll have our new flat screen TVs and video wall in that setup down there – I think it’ll be a more welcoming space than it was previously.

“But at the end of the day, I think customers are just going to be happy to have their traditional main floor racing area back and accessible for the upcoming season.”

With the return of the first floor, guests will be able to enter through the main lobby and have easy access to the grandstand and patio.

Blanchard did indicate, however, that an update to the patio may seep over into the start of the season.

“We have a plan in place to demolish the old concrete patio pad that was out there,” said Blanchard. “We’re going to be repaving a portion of that area, and that will also clean up that space and provide more room out in the outdoor patio area.

“There could be some minor disruption there during the first week, but once everything’s completed, we feel very optimistic about the upcoming season.”

As far as what fans can expect from Western Fair’s live racing product, which is scheduled for each Monday, Tuesday, and Friday at 5:50 p.m. (see website for holiday-related scheduling), major

events include the Ontario Sires Stakes Prospect Series finals on Oct. 11, the 19th edition of Harness the Hope on Oct. 18, and the Drivers Holiday Challenge on Dec. 10.

In between the on-track festivities is the third edition of the London Classic Yearling Sale. Viewing begins on Oct. 14 at 10 a.m., with the sale running Oct. 15 and 16 at noon.

“It’s become a very critical part of what we do here at Western Fair as it pertains to the horse racing industry,” said Blanchard. “We’ve got what we think is our sweet spot in terms of numbers for this year’s event. We have 262 cataloged for the sale, and that’s about the perfect number for our indoor space.”

Blanchard added that this year’s crop, which features yearlings from a pair of tantalizing new sires, will be defined as “quality over quantity.”

“We’re tremendously excited to see the first crop of Bulldog Hanover and the first Ontario crop of Cattlewash; we have several by him,” he said. “And then when you see what a trotting sire like Green Manalishi [S] has done this summer, it’ll be very interesting to see how his crop sells this fall.

“Plus, we’ve already got so many great established Ontario stallions and world class consigners here in the area – so many that can breed horses that can compete anywhere in the world – it’s something we’re very proud of.”

This year’s running of the sale is especially meaningful for Western Fair, as it will be directly tied to the Southwestern Ontario track’s beloved City of London Series.

Not only will Western Fair’s long-standing staple return in the spring under a new moniker (London Classic Sales Series), but a portion of the gross revenue from the sale will also be used to support the local series.

“The sale will bolster those events,” said Blanchard. “We’ll have guaranteed finals going for \$40,000 this year, which is a nice bump [from last season’s finals that ranged from \$23,000-30,000]. We’re thrilled about that, and just happy to have the yearling sale supporting the local industry and vice versa.”

Everything on Western Fair’s plate, present and future, is approached with a forward-thinking mindset, paired with the goal of providing a premium racing product for its loyal fanbase.

“Everything should support what we’re doing,” said Blanchard. “That’s our goal. We want a good racing product here to support the sale. We want the sale conversely, to be supporting the local racing product. It’s about keeping the cycle moving.”

The Charity Challenge was the brainchild of prominent owner Marvin Katz, who wanted to see the annual Breeders Crown event have an impact on more than just those competing on the track.

"The idea that we would just have all these big races and all these people come into town, race for all this money and not try to give something back to the communities that were hosting it, I felt was not in the best interest of the industry or the racetracks or the communities and we could do a better job," Katz previously told HRU.

Since its inception in 2019, when the Breeders Crown was held at Katz's home track of Woodbine Mohawk Park, the BCCC has raised over \$1.5 million.

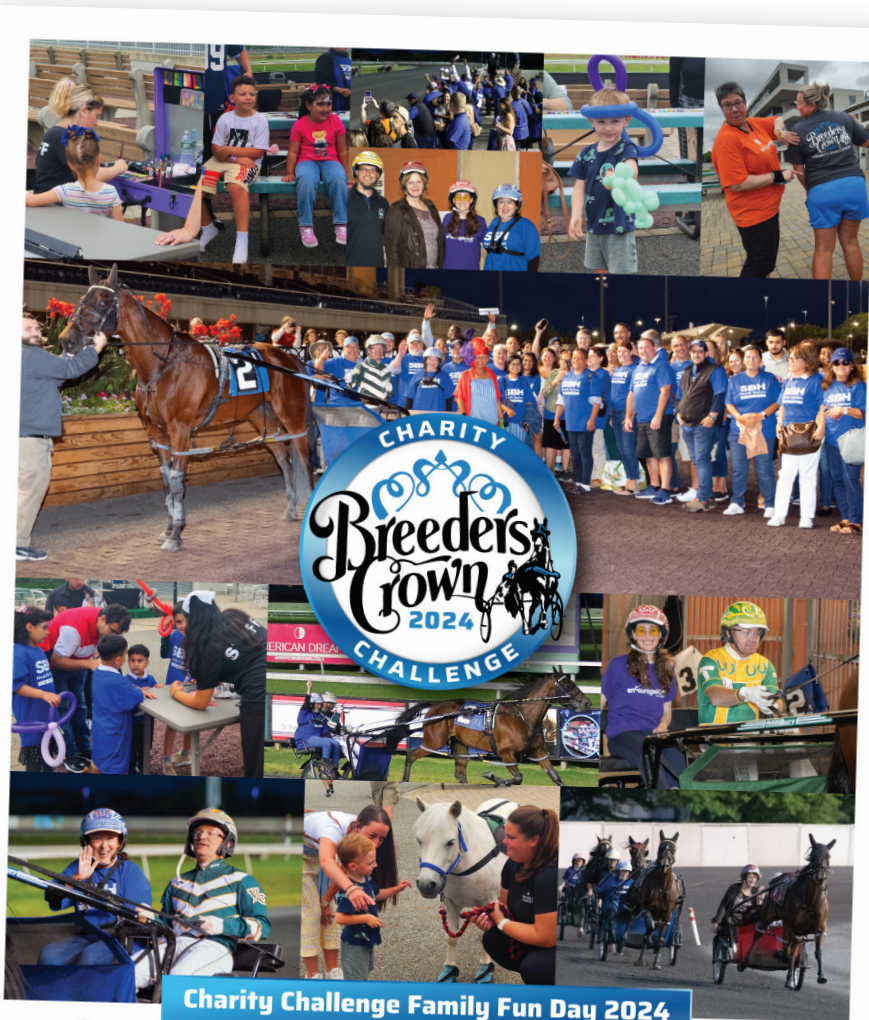
Now in its sixth year, the Charity Challenge is being held at The Meadowlands for a second time. When the East Rutherford, NJ mile oval hosted for the first time back in 2021, over \$400,000 was raised for local charities in the New York/New Jersey area.

Despite already having a winning formula, Katz is not content with the same old, same old, and each year looks to continue to sculpt the Charity Challenge into a better version of its already successful self.

The four Charity Challenge teams are based around a top Grand Circuit driver, and include a trainer and owner(s), as well as a new edition for 2024, an influencer. It is the job of the influencer to hype their team on social media and get people to vote. Voting can be done daily [here](#) and on multiple devices.

The teams were **randomly drawn in the winner's circle** at The Meadowlands on Friday (Aug. 2) and are as follows:

The BCCC officially kicked off this year at The Meadowlands on Friday (Aug. 30) when the **local charities were each paired with a team**. Following the fourth race that night, the charities were able to earn some points for their teams by competing in **charity race** in a double-seater jog cart.

SBH Health System, Bronx, (Team Gingras) with chief financial officer Mary Grochowski, won and collected 50 points, Julie Gallanty, chief executive officer of the New Jersey YMCA State Alliance (Team Miller) was second (25 points), enCourage Kids’ director of development, Emma Wolk (Team Tetrick) finished third (15) and Councilman John Roman representing Friends of Union County (Team Dunn) came home fourth (10 points).

“I can tell you Mary was so nervous about doing it,” said SBH Health System vice president/chief advancement officer Christine Hughes. “But when she got off the horse and I talked to her right afterwards, she said it was the experience of a lifetime.”

Hughes was also appreciative of SBH being chosen as one of the charities for this year’s Challenge.

“We’re not affiliated with any other hospital,” Hughes said. “We’re just a small community hospital. Our biggest issues are gun

violence, food insecurity, homelessness, drug addiction and alcohol addiction. You know, all the things the most impoverished populations deal with.

“Like I said, we’re this scrappy little hospital from the Bronx and if we could win \$50,000, \$100,000, that pays for a nurse for one year for our hospital and one nurse touches thousands and thousands of patients. Wolk was also thrilled to have enCourage Kids be one of the four selected charities and was extremely complimentary of the entire weekend of events, which also included an inaugural Charity Challenge Family Fun Day on Saturday (Aug. 31).

“The kickoff event was fantastic, and it was clear how much effort went into putting together a wonderful weekend,” Wolk said. “The charity team draw, where each organization was paired with their team for the Challenge, was very exciting. enCourage Kids also had the wonderful opportunity to present to the winner of the third race that evening in the winner’s circle.

“To close out the evening, as the ambassador for enCourage Kids, I was delighted to participate in a harness race. I had no idea what to expect, and frankly, was a little bit terrified. The drivers were amazingly kind and offered instructions and tips on the ins and outs of racing and what to expect, which helped to calm my nerves. We made our way to the start, and before I knew it, the horses were picking up speed and we took off. It was exhilarating to experience the power of the horse and the

synergy between the drivers and the horses up close. It was a once-in-a-lifetime experience I'll never forget!"

Gallanty mentioned that the New Jersey YMCA Alliance – with 30 YMCAs at 84 locations across the state serving over 500,000 annually – was honored to be selected for the Charity Challenge.

"It was great competing in the harness race," Gallanty said. "It is an invigorating sport and to participate in a race on a racetrack is an experience I will always remember."

According to Hughes, who had a lot of children attend the Charity Challenge Family Fun Day, it was a rousing success.

"There was face painting, there were little pet-therapy ponies that were awesome," Hughes said. "There were balloon sculptures, there was a DJ and he wore an SBH T-shirt and that was fantastic. There was tons of food. It was like a big barbecue. It was just a great, great, fantastic day."

According to The Big M website (more information can be found [here](#)), the BCCC runs through Oct. 19 and that the team with the most points at the end of the Challenge will receive 40 per cent of the total donated money while the other three charities – in order – will receive 25 per cent, 17.5 per cent and 17.5 per cent, respectively."

According to Katz, the chosen charities have all been doing their part in supporting their teams, which ultimately is why the Charity Challenge was created to make that bond between our sport and its surrounding community.

"It just presents our sport in the most positive manner possible and we have to do it more and more often..." Katz said. "It's incumbent on us to give back to our community, and this is what the Breeders Crown Charity Challenge is about, giving back to the communities."

"As John Campbell says, [the Charity Challenge has] now become an event within the event and it's become integral to the Breeders Crown celebration and it just gets bigger and better every year. And as was said at the outset, we've expanded its footprint to make it even a bigger, better part of the Breeders Crown celebration."

## Gundersen stable on fire

The Norwegian-bred 3- and 4-year-old colts and geldings made up Sunday's (Sept. 8) \$125,000 Kriteriet and \$165,000 Derby and it all ended with dominance from Geir Vegard and Magnus Teien Gundersen. Both races were won by horses from the Gundersen stable and they both impressed in their races, respectively.

In the Kriteriet for 3-year-olds, Magnus Teien sat behind his father's Googoo Gaagaa son **Nadal B.R.** and despite a trip outside of favorite Timestile R, Magnus Teien's horse proved strongest and claimed the victory in a mile rate of 1:59 over 1.3 miles.

Favorite Timestile R held for second place while Felix Halbak finished strongly between horses in third.

In the Derby for 4-year-olds, Magnus Teien sat behind the heavy favorite Just Like Heaven and it all seemed safe and clear when the duo hit the lead after a kilometer. Certainly, Just Like Heaven had to do some hard work three wide before he came to the front position, but it still looked pretty controlled as the field turned for home. But stablemate **Charron** (Code Bon), driven by Geir Vegard wanted to be a part of the game. Geir Vegard left fourth over with a half mile to go and Charron had to race three wide the rest of the race. That didn't stop Charron from challenging his leading stablemate and Geir Vegard refused to let his son Magnus Teien fly away on the lead. Charron's performance was nothing but impressive as he disarmed Just Like Heaven by a nose in a mile rate of 1:57.2 over 1.6 miles. It was big dominance by Gundersens behind the two top horses, while Powwow finished third.

Charron is bred and owned by Morten Langli, well known sports commentator in Norway, and also known as one of the co-owners of Greenshoe. A true interest for the harness racing business paid off well for him at Bjerke last Sunday.

And speaking of the Gundersen stable, American-bred **Devilish Hill** (Muscle Hill—Devilish Delight) continues to show great capacity in Europe and in Wednesday's (Sept. 11) Breeders Crown qualification in Halmstad, the 4-year-old Muscle Hill son captured his fourth win in six starts this year. Among his earlier wins, the 1:51.2 victory in \$100,000 Fyraåringseliten at Solvalla stands out.

On the same night in Halmstad, Björn Goop trained **San Moteur** (Panne de Moteur) had a comeback after his performance in the \$1,050,000 Åby World Grand Prix on Aug. 10, where he finished

fourth behind horses like Horsy Dream and Francesco Zet. This time San Moteur started from post 1 behind the gate in the \$25,000 Hallandsmästaren and the race developed perfectly for the big favorite. San Moteur attacked from second over in the last turn and flew to an easy win in a mile rate of 1:54.3 over 1.3 miles.

## STARS ENTER VINCENNES SATURDAY

Jean-Michel Bazire can't win Saturday's (Sept. 14) \$335,000 Criterium des 4 ans at Vincennes. However, he has two great shots in the two other Criterium-races. Bazire will stand on the side of the track when the best French-bred 4-year-olds (K-horses) battle at Vincennes, but in the \$335,000 Criterium des 3 ans he will try to claim the race for the first time as a trainer. His Liza Josselyn will be one of the favorites in the event and Bazire will most certainly find himself the big favorite behind Jushua Tree in the \$335,000 Criterium des 5 ans. It's teeming with good, strong horses in the three Criterium races and beside the winter meeting's all Grand Prix-events, this race card is a real highlight.

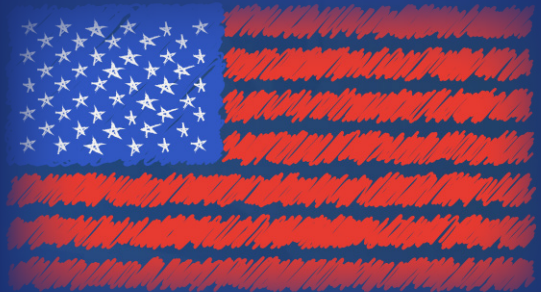

# Elims set for Metro Pace, Trotting Classic and more at Woodbine Mohawk Park

The \$1 million Metro Pace for rookie pacing colts and geldings will have two eliminations Saturday (Sept. 14) at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The Metro Pace eliminations are two of nine stake races on Saturday's outstanding 13-race card at the Campbellville oval.

The \$205,000 Milton Stakes for pacing mares is the feature race, while eliminations will be held for the Canadian Trotting Classic, Elegantimage and She's A Great Lady.

The finals for all of this Saturday's eliminations will be held on Sept. 21, as part of Mohawk Million night.

Here is an outline of some of the top contenders in Saturday's eliminations.

## METRO PACE

This year's Metro Pace final will be the first since 2012 to have a purse of \$1 million and has attracted 17 2-year-old pacing colts and geldings for the eliminations.

New Jersey Classic winner Captain Optimistic (post 2, Yannick Gingras) is the co-headliner in the first \$40,000 elimination. The Nancy Takter trained son of Captaintreacheros has won four of five starts, including last week's stake at The Meadowlands in 1:50.1.

Pennsylvania Sires Stakes champion Papis Rocket (post 1, James MacDonald) enters with plenty of momentum after his victory in last week's rich final. The son of Papi Rob Hanover is trained by Ron Burke and has collected three wins and seven top-three finishes from eight starts.

The first Metro elimination is carded as race 5.

The Burke barn will be well-represented in the second Metro Pace elimination by the undefeated Swingtown (post 1, Chris Page). The son of Downbytheseaside started his career with a win in the Next Generation Stake before winning four more Ohio Sired events.

Swingtown will put his perfect five-for-five record on the line against seven rivals on Saturday.

Scott McEneny trainee Boxer Seelster (post 7, Trevor Henry) is a two-time Grand Circuit winner. The son of Bettors

Delight won a division of the Champlain Stakes last Saturday after already winning the \$230,000 Nassagaweya Stakes on Aug. 24.

# It's My Show returns in style, Hers Hungry upsets at The Red Mile

On Tuesday (Sept. 10) Canadian Pacing Derby champion and 2023 Little Brown Jug victor, **It's My Show**, used a blistering final quarter-mile to defeat the talented El Rey in 1:49.2 in the \$35,000 third leg of the Kentucky Sire Stakes Series (KYSS) for 4-year-old male pacers. **Hers Hungry** hit the line a neck in front of favored Strong Poison to capture the \$35,000 third leg for 4-year-old mare pacers.

It's My Show (Scott Zeron) began pacing from post position 3 in the field of eight while the speedy El Rey (Andy Miller) assumed command right from the beginning of the mile. The public's third choice clicked off fractions of :27.2, :55.3 and 1:22.4 while It's My Show started in fifth and moved into fourth at the three-quarter pole. As the field rounded the final bend, It's My Show began to uncork his rally in the drive for the finish line and was positioned in third behind pocket-sitter Speaking Volumes (Tony Hall).

El Rey had the jump on the 2023 North American winner, but It's My Show came storming over the red clay with a final quarter of :25.4 to best El Rey, who was not throwing in the towel, by a half-length. Speaking Volumes was third.

Trained by Linda Toscano, It's My Show set his lifetime mark of 1:46.4, which was then a world record, at this facility in 2023 Kentucky Sire Stakes Championship Series action. After his triumph in the Little Brown Jug, the gelding went off form towards the end of the season. It took some time to find that form again in 2024 but after his rousing win in the \$399,000 Canadian Pacing Derby on Aug. 31 at Woodbine Mohawk Park it appears It's My Show is back where he belongs: in the spotlight.

The son of Sweet Lou—Put On A Show, champions in their days on the track, was bred by his owners, Richard and Joanne Young. He now sports a resume of 36 12-8-3 with \$1.48 million in the bank.

It's My Show provided his supporters with \$2.72 to win.

Hers Hungry threw down a sizzling final quarter-mile of her own to give Zeron a sweep of the sire stakes for 4-year-olds on the 15-race card to stave off heavily favored Strong

Poison by a neck in 1:49. It was a lifetime best for the daughter of Stay Hungry—Injeanous Style.

Keep My Secret and Tony Hall snatched the early lead from the rail and led the field of five through the first quarter in :28.1. Strong Poison and David Miller left from post position 2. The duo pulled prior to the half-mile marker after sitting in second to click off times of :55.3 and 1:22.2.

Hers Hungry left from post position 4 and remained there until advancing into third turning for home. Strong Poison still had plenty of pace, but Hers Hungry had more, as she used a :25.3 final quarter to ensure she was the mare who would be having her picture taken. Keep My Secret rounded out the trifecta.

Trained by Travis Kolaczynski, Hers Hungry improved her career slate to 30 8-7-0 and she has earned \$76,717 in purse money.

The mare is a half-sibling to Winner Is Coming (Betting Line, \$148,302) and Style For A Mile (Captaintreachous, \$319,288). She was a \$27,000 purchase by Jeffrey Dauplaise and Aimee Scheid at the 2021 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale.

Hers Hungry's great granddam is Hall of Fame member Delinquent Account and her granddam, Art Account, foaled five offspring that broke the \$100,000 barrier.

The mare was bred by All For Won and paid \$28.20 to win.

Racing continues at The Red Mile on Sunday (Sept. 15) with eight \$400,000 Kentucky Sire Stakes Championship Series finals with a first post of 5:05 p.m. On Monday (Sept. 16) the Lexington oval will feature the \$100,000 Commonwealth Series finals and on Tuesday (Sept. 17) the \$50,000 Golden Rod Series finals.

There will be a hiatus at The Red Mile until the Grand Circuit rolls into the Bluegrass on Thursday (Sept. 26) for a two-week sojourn.

# Lots of love for Valentine Bluechip in OSS Grassroots

Three-year-old trotting filly **Valentine Bluechip** lived up to her honor as the heavily backed favorite in the second of three \$20,000 Ontario Sires Stakes Grassroots divisions at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Tuesday (Sept. 10), delivering a 2½-length victory in the swiftest time among the divisions of 1:55.

The sophomore fillies met for the final leg of the regular season for their division with their finals slated for Sept. 28 at Woodbine Mohawk Park and consolations on Sept. 27.

Bet down to 1-9, Valentine Bluechip went to the gate with Doug McNair on board on the rail. The filly eased off the gate into fifth while point-leading Mass Cara (Austin Sorrie) took the top with an opening quarter in :27.4. Mass Cara trotted to the midway point uncontested in :57.2. After that mark, McNair was the first to pull the right line and move Valentine Bluechip first-up to contest the leader. Valentine Bluechip progressed quickly and poked a head in front at the three-quarters in 1:26.2. From there, the filly moved up and out, finishing in the center of the track by 2½ lengths in 1:55. Exciting Mia (Chris Christoforou) followed her cover to second with Shetrotsalot (Scott Young) rounding out the top three.

Trained by Gregg McNair for owner Anthony Timmins, Valentine Bluechip is a 3-year-old daughter

of Muscle Mass and the Royalty For Life mare Shesa Sweetheart. With just a win and a third in two starts as a freshman, the filly has showcased a career year this year, standing at 6-1-0 in eight starts with \$79,250 of her \$89,790 lifetime sum banked as a sophomore. She paid \$2.10 for the win.

**Rhythm Of Life** (\$2.90) trotted a career-best 1:55.3 mile to take the first of the OSS Grassroots splits of the evening. Bob McClure was back in the bike for trainer Shawn Steacy as they won from post 7 by 2¼ lengths.

Landmark 16 Racing Stable, Glengate Farms, Carmen Chrysdale and Guy Haskell co-own the Muscle Mass—Royal Rhythm filly. Rhythm Of Life earned her fourth-straight win and is now five-for-16 on the year. From 23 career starts, she has six wins and \$125,197 in earnings.

**Love Those Legs** (\$2.80) and Louis-Philippe Roy completed the trio of stakes divisions, winning from post 7 by three-quarters-of-a-length in 1:55.2 as the bettors' choice.

Luc Blais trains the Kadabra—Legzy filly for Determination. With a new lifetime mark in the mile, she recorded her third win of the year in 12 starts after a winless, seven-race rookie campaign. She has banked \$71,906 in lifetime earnings.
