Captain Albano delivers Daley and McCarthy's first Jug victory

Five years after returning to the U.S., trainer Noel Daley celebrated a special victory in Delaware, OH.

Noel Daley decided in 2018 he was done with American racing.

The winner of more than \$61 million in purses and countless trophies, Daley decided it was time to head home to Australia to raise his son, Max, closer to family. So he let go of his dozens of horses, many of them champions, and closed up his training enterprise.

The exile lasted one year.

Daley returned to the U.S. in 2019 and had literally nothing with which to restart his stable — "I didn't even have a screw eye." But he still had his keen eye for horses and the training skills that had him ranked for years among harness racing's best.

Five years later, those two factors carried Daley to the Little Brown Jug winner's circle for the first time in his illustrious career.

Daley's charge **Captain Albano** went off as the 3-5 favorite and romped to a 3½-length victory Thursday (Sept. 19) in the \$625,000 Little Brown Jug at the Delaware County Fairgrounds, over Mirage Hanover and Legendary Hanover in 1:51.3.

"It's great to see it done," Daley said with a smile.

Captain Albano's win also provided the first Jug for 31-year-old driver Todd McCarthy, a fellow Australian, who in four years of U.S. racing has already earned more than \$32 million in purses.

Captain Albano was a surprise winner of the first elimination heat at 3-1, going straight to the lead off the gate from the rail and never looking back, romping in 1:49.2. Captain Luke, Mirage Hanover and Huntingforchrome also qualified for the final.

Daley admitted he was caught off guard seeing Captain Albano on the front so early.

"We pretty much decided we were taking him off the gate, but as soon as I saw him go I thought, 'I guess [McCarthy] went to Plan B," Daley said. "He said everyone looked relaxed behind



It was the first Jug victory for both trainer Noel Daley (black shirt) and driver Todd McCarthy (blue and green colors).

Jamieson is no stranger to Delaware, having won in 2007 with Tell All. He hadn't had a contender since finishing seventh in 2011 with Up The Credit.

"The whole thing about the Jug is you have to have a top colt, and I just haven't had a top colt to get to race here," he said. "It

means a lot that I could be here, and it's even more fun."

When Captain Albano took to the track for the final, leaving from post 2 as the race favorite, Daley had simple instructions for his driver: "I said, 'Just don't get locked in. Just come out and sit outside.' It worked out great."

Captain's Quarters took the lead in the final, and McCarthy stayed close behind in second through much of the mile, before sling-shotting around the final turn and leaving his rival in the fading September sun.

Captain Albano pulled clear and won going away, with McCarthy barely urging him on. Captain's Quarters faded to seventh.

"It wasn't until the top of the stretch that I sort of had to start making a plan to get going," McCarthy said. "At that point, the pace wasn't overly fast, and I was content to have him sit out there. The rest of it was pretty cool."

McCarthy said winning for Daley made the race even more special.

the gate, and they didn't look like they were going to leave. It worked out pretty good for us."

The heavy favorite, Nijinsky, who had only lost once in his 10 previous starts this year, made a move along the backside, but faded quickly.

Trainer Anthony Beaton said the pacer was making noise in his throat when he pulled up, but it would take post-race diagnostics to figure out exactly what happened.

"We'll have the vets scope him later on and see what's up there," Beaton said. "Hopefully it's nothing major, and we can get ready for the next go round."

The No. 1 post also proved lucky for Captain's Quarters and Jody Jamieson, who went gate-to-wire, winning by a head over Total Stranger in 1:51.3 at odds of 5-1.

Once again, the heavy favorite failed to impress, as Legendary Hanover was third by a length after a brutal trip. Sweet Beach Life also qualified.

"Noel's been a great family friend of ours for a long time now and a huge supporter of mine from when I first got here, and he stuck with me all the way through," he said. "I can't thank him enough for that. For us, to be able to win a race like this today is really special."

Before Thursday, Daley's best Little Brown Jug finish was in 1997 when The Wiz finished second to Western Dreamer, although he and McCarthy's brother, Andrew, had teamed in 2017 to win the Jugette with Caviart Ally.

Daley had bought Captain Albano (Captaintreacherous—Angelou) for \$150,000 as a yearling from the 2022

Standardbred Horse Sales Company auction in Harrisburg, PA. He has now trained the horse — bred by Fred Hertrich III of All American Harnessbreds fame — to \$1.24 million in earnings for owners Patricia Stable, L.A. Express Stable, Sjoblom Inc. and Michael Dolan.

"You like to come back and win good races," he said. "You like to have good horses.

"It's nice when things turn out."


Captain's Quarters (Jody Jamieson) went gate-to-wire in the second heat, winning by a head over Total Stranger in 1:51.3.

\$90,000 MS VERSATILITY FINAL (OLDER MARE TROT)

The Norwegian-bred **Nelsonbriteagle No** benefited from early breaks in stride by HP Mama B (Louis Roy) and Tipsy Money (Yannick Gingras) and was able to coast to a 7¾-length romp in 1:52.3.

The 6-year-old Bold Eagle mare is co-owned by trainer Ake Svanstedt and breeder Nils Munkhaugen.

Adare Castle (James MacDonald) was second and Tactical Mounds (Scott Zeron) was third.



\$92,150 OLD OAKEN BUCKET (3-YEAR-OLD COLT TROT)

Four Sixes (Gingras) minded his manners and went gate-to-wire in a lifetime best 1:54.

Vanguard (Todd McCarthy) and Elhelpski (Peter Wrenn) both overcame breaks in stride to secure the place and show spots.

The winning son of Six Pack is co-owned by William Hartt and trainer Melissa Beckwith.

\$50,000 STANDARDBRED (2-YEAR-OLD COLT TROT)

Arrowhead Hanover received a patient drive from Anthony MacDonald and won the Standardbred by 1½ lengths over Abraham Hanover (Mike Wilder) and Lefties Righties (Zeron).

The International Moni gelding is owned by the fractional ownership group, The Stable.

The winning time of 1:55.2 was a new lifetime mark for Arrowhead Hanover who has now won \$82,170 this season.

\$47,000 STANDARDBRED (2-YEAR-OLD COLT PACE)

Dreamboat Hanover (Andy Miller) capitalized on an early quick pace by Railroad Station (David Miller) and swept by the tiring leader around the final turn to win in 1:51.2.

Fasting (Jeremy Indof) was 4¼-lengths back in second, Waitingforguffman (Ronnie Wrenn, Jr.) third and Railroad Station was fourth.

The Papi Rob Hanover gelding is trained by co-owner Todd Schadel, Christine Schadel, Timothy Hayes and Dr. Megan Moschgat.

\$145,000 (DIV.) OHIO BREEDERS CHAMPIONSHIP (2-YEAR-OLD COLT PACE)

The undefeated **Rick Wink** (Chris Page) took control of the field of six at the quarter-mile pole and sprinted six lengths clear of Extra Suds (Brett Miller) and House Of Brix (Trevor Smith) to take the second division.

The 1:50.2 final time established a new stakes record and was just two-fifths-of-a-second off the world mark.

The Bit Of A Legend N colt is conditioned by Ron Burke for the Burke Racing Stable, R A S Stable, Knox Services, J&T Silva-Purnel-Libby. He was bred by Larry R. Miller.

Rick Wink, who was a \$27,000 yearling purchase, has not tasted defeat in seven seasonal starts and now has earned \$207,250.

Bars And Notes (Tyler Smith) skimmed the pylons in the stretch to go from worst to first in the first division.

The pacesetting Downbythewater (Chris Lems) was second and Fabio Hanover (Wrenn, Jr.) was third.

The winner is co-owned by trainer Joseph Lucas and At The Wire Farms.

The final time of 1:53.1 was a new lifetime best for the gelded son of Racing Hill who was bred by Kevin Greenfield and Michael Creps.

\$131,200 OHIO BREEDERS CHAMPIONSHIP (3-YEAR-OLD COLT PACE)

Outer Banks (Page) kept the challenging Paris's Dragon (Dan Noble) in the pocket long enough to score a neck victory in the second division in 1:52.1.

The Downbytheseaside gelding is owned by Burke Racing Stable, R A S Stable, J&T Silva-Purnel-Libby and Weaver Bruscemi.

The winner was purchased for \$50,000 as a yearling from the breeder Frank Nanna.

Janelle Granny (Dexter Dunn) used a three-wide move in the final turn and wore down the leading Clever Cody (Aaron Merriman) in the first \$65.600 division. Hundred Dollar Man (Montrell Teague) was a closing third.

Trainer Virgil Morgan, Jr. continued his hot streak with this Fear The Dragon colt, who is owned by Betty Jo Clegg.

Janelle Granny lowered his lifetime mark with the 1:49.4 victory.

\$118,200 OHIO BREEDERS CHAMPIONSHIP (3-YEAR-OLD FILLY PACE)

Calypso Pearl (Dan Noble) survived a two-prong stretch challenge from the outside Seaside Diva (Chris Page) and the inside Katies Up (Yannick Gingras) to score a neck win in 1:51.2.

Christi Noble trains the homebred winner for Sandra Burnett.

The Fear The Dragon filly won for the fifth time in 2024 after going unraced at 2.

\$115,200 OHIO BREEDERS CHAMPIONSHIP (3-YEAR-OLD COLT TROT)

Spaaaanzano (Merriman) and Tennessee Tom (Page) has been battling each other for the past two years and this time Spaaaanzano came out on top by three lengths in 1:53.2.

Tennessee Tom edged Royal Precedent (Wrenn, Jr.) in a place photo.

The Coraggioso gelding is trained and co-owned by Chris Beaver who he shares ownership with Spaaaartners, Bill Manes and Leo Fleming.

SBOANJ president Mark Ford says, "it's a very big shock" Freehold Raceway will cease operating in December

In a statement released by management at Freehold Raceway on Thursday (Sept. 19), the racetrack in central New Jersey "expects to cease all live racing and simulcast operations as of Dec. 28, 2024."

When contacted by HRU for a comment on Thursday morning after word broke, it was obvious that the news was still sinking in with Mark Ford, president of the Standardbred Breeders and Owners Association of New Jersey.

"We've been in discussion with Freehold about the problems there for several years now," Ford said. "And not that we didn't see it coming, but it's a very big shock. We didn't know anything about it until this morning like everybody else did. So, we have to step back and take a deep breath and make sure that we get what's coming to us."

When asked if he had given any thought to adding dates to The Meadowlands calendar for next year to try and accommodate some of the Freehold horses that are possibly good enough to race at The Meadowlands, president/chief executive officer Jeff Gural said, "I would consider adding dates to help the horsemen provided it makes economic sense. Surprised they stayed open so long."

Freehold, known as "The Afternoon Delight," was established in 1853 and according to their website is the nation's oldest and fastest daytime half mile harness racing track. Despite the fact that Goshen Historic Track was established in 1838, unlike Freehold, it is no longer pari-mutuel.

"This was an extremely difficult decision, especially given the historical importance of Freehold Raceway to the local community and the New Jersey horse racing industry," said general manager Howard Bruno in the released

statement. "Unfortunately, the operations of the racetrack cannot continue under existing conditions, and we do not see a plausible way forward. We are incredibly thankful for our dedicated employees, horsemen and fan base for their support and patronage for so many years.

"The remainder of the approved live racing schedule for 2024 will be completed and daily simulcasting will continue until the closure date. Freehold officials are working proactively with the New Jersey Racing Commission, state and local officials, and industry stakeholders on all necessary items related to the closure of the facility. Severance will be paid to employees, including compensation as required by New Jersey's Worker Adjustment and Retraining (WARN) Act, and any applicable collective bargaining agreements."

Even though perhaps the writing may have been on the wall when Freehold closed its sportsbook just prior to the start of football season, sources say they were stunned to hear that the track would cease racing at the end of the year.

According to those sources, letters were handed out to employees last Thursday (Sept. 12), the same day the Governor of New Jersey signed the horse racing appropriation bill extending support of the industry through 2029. The Sept. 12 letters asked the employees to attend the Sept. 19 meeting in which the track's closure was announced.

Connections take a shot with Soft Shot and take Jugette title

Soft Shot, a supplemental entry, equaled the world record in her elimination and used a gate-to-wire effort in the final to win the \$310,000 Jugette for 3-year-old filly pacers on Wednesday (Sept. 18) at the Delaware County Fair.

When the field of eight was sent on their way in the \$260,000 final, they paced the first three-eighths of a mile in post-position order with Soft Shot (David Miller) and My Girl EJ (Dexter Dunn) pacing one and two.

As the field passed the grandstand the first time, the pocket sitting My Girl EJ experienced an equipment break, broke stride and was taken to the outside.

The break caused confusion in the back of the pack and gave Soft Shot a five-length lead at the half in :56.1.

A Few Choice Words (Jim Marohn, Jr.) tried to close the gap at the three-quarters in 1:23.4, but Miller and Soft Shot used a :27.1 final panel to score the 1:51 victory.


A Few Choice Words edged out Odds On Platinum (Todd McCarthy) for second, 2½-lengths behind the winner.

When asked if this was the greatest day in his racing career, the winning owner, Paul O'Neil of Saratoga Springs, NY said, "By far. Nothing even close. We were three-for-three today."

Trainer Jessica Roegner and O'Neil won an Ohio Fair Racing Conference pace earlier on the card.

The connections of Soft Shot made the \$15,000 entry payment just to make the Heston Blue Chip—Aims Whisper filly eligible for the 54th edition of the pacing classic.

"We were here for the fun," said Roegner. "She was just amazing."

With the Jugette win, Miller moves into a second-place tie with three driving titles.

Soft Shot has now won 11 of 14 starts this season and is 13-for-20 lifetime. With her \$142,500 payday, her career earnings jump to \$245,078.

When asked what was next for her and the filly, a jubilant Roegner said, "To just get through the night."

JUGETTE ELIMS RECAP

The first elimination was a gate-to-wire effort for Soft Shot in 1:49.3, a time that equaled the stake, track and world record set by Party Girl Hill in 2020.

A Few Choice Words came out of the pocket to challenge, but couldn't get closer than the final margin of $1\frac{1}{2}$ lengths.

The field's other supplemental entry, Dandy's Mercy (Scott Zeron) was third and Donegal Spirit (Todd McCarthy) was the final horse to advance to the final.

The only bad news for Soft Shot's connections today was that their piece of the world record lasted only about 35 minutes.

In the second \$25,000 elimination, My Girl EJ lowered the mark to 1:49.1.



Up (Chris Lems) was less than a length back in second. Triump Over You (Trevor Smith) was third.





Battle Hill and Chris Lems benefited from a couple of opportune breaks in stride by a challenger and a leader and won the first \$68,500 division.



MEADOWLANDS MATTERS

with DEBBIE LITTLE

Win, lose or draw formula

The Meadowlands has come up with a unique twist on how it will draw for stakes finals, a system aimed to please both owners and bettors.

The origin of the phrase "the luck of the draw" dates back to the 19th century, and, presumably, has been linked with horse racing since its inception.

However, these days, at least when it comes to elimination racing, in most cases it's more about the luck of the draw formula.

From country to country, track to track, and even race to race, different conditions dictate how said final draw will be done.

Is one method better than the rest? It depends on who you ask.

Hall of Famer Ron Burke has always been clear about where he stands on the matter when it comes to eliminations.


"If you win, you pick your post," Burke told HRU prior to the Hambletonian final in 2023. "It's what the Adios does. [By winning the elimination] you earned the right to pick your post. To me, pick your post is the best. To me, pick your post or open draw, either way. I don't subscribe to the go around there for the eliminations and just make the final thing; we try to win. People bet on the races. Our job is to go out and try to win every time. So, I don't need that to try to win. I'm going to try to win anyhow. And plus, a \$100,000 purse [for the eliminations] is enough reason to win."

Over time, the Hambletonian Society has modified the draw formula for elimination winners of America's Trotting Classic, from open draw, to picking their post, to the current conditions where they draw for posts 1 through 5.

The draw method used for tomorrow night's (Sept. 21) finals at Woodbine Mohawk Park are similar to the Hambletonian, except that the elimination winners in Campbellville, ON, drew for posts 2 through 6.

Despite the fact that the Hambletonian is currently raced at The Meadowlands, they follow their own conditions and not those of their host track, which takes a slightly different approach.

Although only adopted at The Meadowlands since the 2022 season, the current draw formula was created nearly two decades ago by newly-minted Hall of Famer Bob Boni.



The overall concept is to give a balance between the ownership and the betting public so that you're not beating up the ownership, who without that group, we have no racing, and if the betting public doesn't think it's a bettable product, you know, we're kidding ourselves there also. So, I thought about it a lot and then came up with an idea that gave you a reason to win, but also just as important, it gave you a reason to finish second and not third. Because when it used to be that the winners draw inside, at the top of the stretch if you're going to be second, third or fourth it doesn't make a whole lot of difference because you're in the open draw.

Boni, who grew up going to the races, said he wasn't a fan of the method currently used in Delaware, OH, for the Little Brown Jug, where, depending on the number of elims, the winners drew for posts 1, 2 or even 3, and the second-place finishers drew for the next inside posts, etc.

"It sets up a terrible betting race, especially on a half-mile track," Boni said. "There are a couple of factions that I felt needed to be taken care of in our business, and the factions are the horsemen and the gamblers. I think we have certain people that seem to disregard one or the other and that's when they get in trouble."

Boni was also not a fan of an open draw, one of which inspired him to come up with his formula.

"I remember the race that sort of really pushed me to say we got to do something about this and I'll tell you which race it was," Boni said. "It was Malabar Man and it stuck in my mind when he won the Hambletonian."


In 1997, Bowlin For Dollars won the first Hambletonian elimination, while Malabar Man won the second and Yankee Glide the third. For the final, Yankee Glide drew post 3, Malabar Man got post 4 and Bowlin For Dollars ended up with post 9. Malabar Man won the race, while Bowlin For Dollars, after having to go three-wide early in the race, finished fourth while Yankee Glide broke and finished last.

Boni remembers thinking at the time, "There's an imbalance there."

So, over time, he came up with a formula that would both reward horses that finished well as well as make for a good betting race.

"The overall concept is to give a balance between the ownership and the betting public so that you're not beating up the ownership, who without that group, we have no racing, and if the betting public doesn't think it's a bettable product, you know, we're kidding ourselves there also," Boni said. "So, I thought about it a lot and then came up with an idea that gave you a reason to win, but also just as important, it gave you a reason to finish second and not third. Because when it used to be that the winners draw inside, at the top of the stretch if you're going to be second, third or fourth it doesn't make a whole lot of difference because you're in the open draw. On a mile track, [with this formula] you can't draw outside of the 7, and to me there's a big difference drawing the 7 or the 8, 9 or 10."

Using two eliminations as the example, as explained on The Meadowlands website, winners would draw for posts 1 to 6, the second-place finishers would draw for post 7 and down, eliminating positions selected by the winners, the third-place finishers would draw for post 8 and down, eliminating positions already selected, the fourth-place finishers would draw for post 9 and down, eliminating positions already selected, and the fifth-place finishers would draw for the remaining positions, one of which would be post 10. It is in play for any stake that is Meadowlands administered and requires eliminations: the Meadowlands Pace, NJ Classic and Fall Final Four.

As the simulcast and sponsorship director and second announcer in Delaware, OH, Jason Settlemoir deals with a very different draw system that according to the conditions on the USTA website "Post positions for final heat to be determined by order of finish of first heat with the winner of the second heat being the winner of the Little Brown Juq."

According to Settlemoir, who is also the chief operating officer/ general manager at The Meadowlands, they are always looking to do what's best for their customers and horsemen, and for now, this draw formula is fitting the bill.

"We're okay with it at this point and if we need to make changes, we'll always make changes," Settlemoir said. "So, if anybody has a better idea, then please send it along because our goal always is to protect the customer and have integrity driven races and to make sure that our customer is getting a fair shake every time that these horses are on the racetrack, regardless of whether it's an overnight, elimination or a million-dollar race."

The Breeders Crown will be held at The Meadowlands this year but, just like the Hambletonian, it has its own guidelines and thus its own draw system which is that the elimination winners draw for post 1 through 5.

In perhaps an ironic twist, Boni's formula may have helped shape what is done by the Hambletonian Society.

When Boni came up with the formula, he showed it to Hambletonian Society director John Cashman, and while Boni's work was not credited with the change, according to Boni, Cashman later told him it was the initiative for the Hambletonian introducing the policy of winners drawing from 5 and down.

Writer's note: As longtime newspaper writers, my husband Dave and I were often told 'I wasn't going to leave it all out there, when we're going for a million next week.' Quotes like that from drivers that were favored in a race made me hate elimination races. Back then, my husband once wrote that elimination racing should be non-betting but then nobody would watch. So, I applaud any track or entity trying to make elimination racing better for the fans and the owners.











What to watch for across Saturday's signature Mohawk Million card

Two separate million-dollar events combined with classic stakes finals for 2- and 3-year-olds highlight one of the highest anticipated race cards of the year at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Jumping right into it with the Mohawk Million, open to all 2-year-old trotters, 10 horses are represented by just five different trainers and that includes Luc Blais who sends out four separate entries to slots owned by Determination. The breakdown of the race, though, starts with one of the two Marcus Melander trainees, Maryland.

Ever developing, Maryland was massively impressive as a 17-1 upsetter when last seen at Woodbine Mohawk Park two back when he won the William Wellwood final towards the end of August. That night, he went to the lead from post 9, sat the pocket, and once he had room to the inside in the upper stretch he sprinted away nicely from even-money favorite Nordic Catcher S. He followed that up with a win in another half million-dollar race when he jogged last Friday (Sept. 13) in the Peter Haughton at Hoosier, that time as the well-respected 6-5 odds favorite. A win Saturday (Sept.

20) would push him close to \$1 million in earnings in just his last three starts alone.

The fastest mark heading into the race is owned by one of three fillies in the field, that being Monalishi who closed from an improbable early position to win the Peaceful Way final two back in a time of 1:52.2. Unbeaten in her last two starts with James MacDonald driving, she's managed to get the best of fellow rival filly Lasting Dream while racing both from well off cover two races ago and then coming right back next out to do it all on the front end.

Lasting Dream, who it appeared had some brief confusion at the top of the stretch last out and may have been the margin of difference in defeat most recently to Monalishi, is the best of the four Determination and Blais entrants. But another from those connections who warrants a mention is Emoticon Legacy. A well-meant winner last out in her division of the Champlain Stakes, she's yet another representation in the Mohawk Million by her dam and former O'Brien Award winner, Emoticon Hanover. Last year, Emoticon Hanover produced Drawn Impression and was closely related to Emoji Hanover – two horses who raced in last year's edition of the race and who race on the same card this Saturday in the Elegantimage final.

Onajetplane was a big overlay when winning the NJ Classic Final last out at The Meadowlands. He seemed right on par with Hidalgo that race and despite a wide disparity in the odds, he was able to sweep comfortably from third-over to win in a lifetime best of 1:53. Go Ahead Makemyday exits that same race and lacked room from the pocket until Onajetplane was already in flight. It was a good race from both, and both seem capable in this spot.

Working inside out with the remaining four horses, Meshuggah leaves Pennsylvania for the first time in his career. You can't fault his record of having never been worse than second in a bunch of close finishes and Zeron has developed a knack for coming through in these big races, yet to be disproven. Wondrous Blue Chip and Lookatmegoamigo from posts 8 and 9, respectively, seem to be the reaches of the Determination quartet. Torrisi drew the worst of it and despite the respect for the connections and some good money earned in recent Kentucky starts, this filly would need to do something special to win from out here.

Picks: Lasting Dream, Maryland, Monalishi

\$713,000 CANADIAN TROTTING CLASSIC — 3-YEAR-OLD OPEN

In the \$713,000 Canadian Trotting Classic, heavily backed and easy elimination winners Highland Kismet and Sir Pinocchio square off. Sir Pinocchio did it easy last week in a rare appearance outside of New York, while Highland Kismet's elimination win time of 1:51.1 was the faster of the two by over a full second. With Karl's loss earlier in the week at Lexington, his second of the year, I wonder if it opens the door a little more for Highland Kismet to capitalize and close within the divisional rankings. Second to Karl in the Hambletonian, Highland Kismet has been vicious in his last pair and could be the horse to watch heading into the fall.

\$532,000 SHES A GREAT LADY FINAL — 2-YEAR-OLD PACING FILLIES

Chantilly has been nothing short of sensational early in her career and she'll take her unbeaten streak into the \$532,000 She's A Great Lady final. She jogged as usual last week in her elimination and has remained as fast and consistent as she was when first posting that eye opening 1:50.4 mile on July 16, which was matched in her most recent race. As a potential longshot, Nice Buns had an impossible trip against Chantilly in her elimination but at least gave it a shot, would like even more if Dunn opts here over the Pelling trainee.

\$1 MILLION METRO PACE FINAL — 2-YEAR-OLD OPEN

The Metro goes as the other \$1 million race on the Saturday card as one of the premier events of the year for 2-year-old colt pacers. In a race where many of these could win with the right trip, Fallout became the latest 2-year-old this year to win in a time of sub 1:50 when he sprung the mild upset last week at odds of 7-1 in a time of 1:49.3. That marked his fourth straight race timed in under 1:50 and in retrospect those many races against killer Louprint prepared him well for last week. Captain Optimistic brushed and crushed in his elimination win and will likely go off as the lukewarm favorite with the post advantage over most of his main rivals. Swingtown tired late in his elimination as the big favorite. Heavily touted colt from Ohio will offer more

value now while getting a second chance over the big track for Burke. Papi's Pistol surprised Captain Optimistic a few back at The Meadowlands and was used harder than I'm sure Miller would have liked in his elimination and he was pacing evenly enough in the late stages; possible upset call. Prince Hal Hanover outraced his odds in a multiple move elimination try; draws favorably for the final and goes second time McCarthy.

\$347,000 ELEGANTIMAGE — 3-YEAR-OLD TROTTING FILLIES

Drawn Impression drifted a little in her Elegantimage elimination giving the inside path to R Melina but was able to narrowly hang on in a :26 and change trotting sprint to the finish; those two may again be the top two choices with \$347,000 on the line in this stakes final. Emoji Hanover won the other elimination last week, but she hasn't been able to yet figure out either Drawn Impression or R Melina in recent tries against both. Cool Ma Belle took an insane amount of tote action last out against Emoji Hanover and broke into the stretch when it looked like she was just about to get involved. Tactical Strike may have won her elimination had Filion moved off the pylons earlier in the stretch; I have no idea why he didn't.








Mohawk Million: a launchpad to stardom





and it's elder, yet equally renowned companion contest the Metro Pace (first raced in 1988), have worked in tandem to spotlight standardbred racing's next wave of superstars.

The prestigious pair of million-dollar tilts for 2-year-old trotters and pacers, respectively, returns to Mohawk on Saturday (Sept. 21), with a special 6:30 p.m. post time, as part of a dynamic card that includes five stakes finals.

An evening otherwise known as "Canada's Richest Night of Racing."

"Anytime there's a \$1 million dollar race, it's important not only for Mohawk's racing, but for the entire racing industry — whether it be the breeders, trainers, drivers — we don't have as many million-dollar races as we used to," said Bill McLinchey, vice-president for standardbred racing at Woodbine Entertainment. "Anytime you get even one of those, it's significant for the industry."

While the allure of a race like the Mohawk Million is selfexplanatory, McLinchey acknowledged that getting horses behind the starting gate was a struggle during the early days.

"The first year we sold nine slots at \$100,000 U.S.," McLinchey said. "That was the only year we sold the slots in U.S. dollars. Starting in year two, we made it Canadian dollars.

"It was a pretty big risk for anyone to put up that much money, so we knew going into this year's edition that we had to make some changes."

To ensure the new kid in town remained a boon for both Mohawk and the harness racing business, McLinchey and Co. decided to reduce the slot price from \$100,000 to \$50,000.

Added money for the Mohawk Million purse also increased to \$500,000, up from \$100,000 in 2023.

"What that did was make it a lot more economical for more people," he said. "We went from coming right down to the wire every year at the slot sale deadline, hoping to have 10 purchasers, to this year having 21 people signing up to buy a slot.

"It really changed from where it was tough to fill, to all of a sudden there were people lined up wanting in."

The 2024 Million also marks the first iteration in which all 10 slots were available for sale. Previously, only nine were listed with the 10th and final entry going to the winner of the William Wellwood Memorial.

Now open to a wider crop of hopefuls, McLinchey is bullish on the prospect of another burgeoning trotter using the Million as a launchpad to stardom.

And for good reason, given the abundant supply of notable names and thrilling theatrics throughout the years.

"To be honest, it's dramatic from the planning process right until the race itself," McLinchey said with a laugh. "We weren't sure in past years that it was going to fill, so having some phenomenal horses like Venerable — she put on a great performance in 2021 — Venerate winning the first one, and then last year with T C I, who made a break at the start and then came back to win the race. That's something you just don't see in a major stakes race."



Trained by Ron Burke, T C I stormed back from 15-lengths behind the lead to capture last year's Mohawk Million in awe-inspiring fashion.

For all the astonishment to come out of the Million in its short, but spectacular existence, the Metro Pace has been equally important for the next generation of elite pacers.

"If you look back through the years, the Metro is one of the most exciting races on the race calendar," McLinchey said. "It's always gone for big money, but it's always been, what I would say, the marquee race for 2-year-old pacing colts.

"It's the race where you get to show off the rising stars. Maybe we look at the horse who wins this year's running as the one that's going to stamp themselves as the favorite for next year's North America Cup."

After all, the formula has worked before.

"You can go back 20 years when Rocknroll Hanover won the Metro and stamped himself as the best 2-year-old. Then he went on to be the best 3-year-old the following year. It really was that stepping stone for him."

At 31-1, Rocknroll Hanover paid \$64.20 for the Metro victory. The son of Western Ideal—Rich N Elegant went on to earn more than \$3 million across 26 starts (15-5-5) before embarking on a successful career as a stallion.

The bay sired several accomplished starters, including Rock N Roll Heaven (30: 20-6-2; \$2.7 million lifetime earnings), Put On A Show (50: 31-9-2; \$2.4 million), and A Rocknroll Dance (50: 17-10-4; \$2.2 million).

Such a career arc gives McLinchey hope that the next Rocknroll Hanover could reveal themselves on Saturday night.

"We saw a future superstar's coming out party that night," he said. "Maybe there's an opportunity for something like that this time around."

The Metro Pace has served as a litmus test for the sport's top pacers for some 36 years now.

Totally Ruthless scored in the very first edition in 1988 with driver Bill O'Donnell handling the reins.

In the years that followed, Artsplace (1990), Somebeachsomewhere (2007), and Captaintreacherous (2012) all added a Metro Pace title to their Hall of Fame resumes.

While the Metro Pace and Mohawk Million will take center stage on Saturday night, the two marquee matches will be flanked by three more stakes finals - the Canadian Trotting Classic, Elegantimage, and She's A Great Lady.

"You almost feel a little guilty," said McLinchey. "We have a race like the Canadian Trotting Classic, which is a phenomenal race, and it's probably considered a little bit of the undercard with the two million-dollar races on the docket."

Regardless of each race's position on the card, horseplayers will have an abundance of wagering opportunities throughout the evening, including an all stakes Pick-5 starting in race 6.

McLinchey is optimistic that the steady presence of top-tier talent will drive healthy betting pools for horseplayers to engage with.

"I'm hoping they're going to see great racing from race 1 right through to the end of the card," he said. "I feel we have the best horses, best trainers and best drivers, all on one race card.

"There's an opportunity to see something remarkable in every race on Saturday night."

As for the 2-year-olds looking to propel themselves to new heights, McLinchey equated their journey to this moment to one of professional sport's most grueling, but sought-after feats.

"It feels like a culmination of everything for the 2-year-olds that started qualifying at Mohawk in June and have raced in some of our overnights and smaller series all summer," he said. "This is like their World Series."

This year's edition of the Mohawk Million is twice as nice for Blake MacIntosh.

When the field of 10 lines up behind the gate for standardbred racing's richest event for 2-year-old trotters on Saturday night (Sept. 21) at Woodbine Mohawk Park, the horseman who recently surpassed 1,250 career training wins will have two chances, namely, Go Ahead Makemyday, and Monalishi, to win the prestigious race.



And not just as a conditioner – MacIntosh is also a co-owner of both first-year trotters.

"It is so exciting to be in a race like this," MacIntosh said. "We have raced in a lot of big races over the years, but these 2-year-olds are very special to us."

A grey son of Walner—Uvie Hanover, Go Ahead Makemyday made a sudden impact in his first start this June at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

After a pair of 2:00.2 qualifiers at the Milton oval, the colt took top prize in his Tompkins-Geers Stakes final on June 28.

Administrated by the Hambletonian Society, the Tompkins-Geers attracted a single division for both the pacing and trotting events.

Driven by Sylvain Filion, Go Ahead Makemyday got off the wings quickly and went on to notch a 2¼-length win in 1:57.1.

It is the biggest victory to date for the horse (his original Million slot owner was Diamond Creek Farm) bred by Riina Rekila of Siuro, Finland.

He arrives at his highest-profile engagement off a second to Mohawk Million contender Onajetplane in the \$337,838 New Jersey Classic, held at The Meadowlands on Sept. 6.

One week earlier, Go Ahead Makemyday, also co-owned by Van Camp Trotting Corp, Mortgage Boys Stable, and Ozzie Mackay, won his Classic elimination in a career best 1:54.4.

A \$17,000 purchase at the 2023 Lexington Select Yearling Sale, Go Ahead Makemyday is 3-2-0 from seven starts, accompanied by \$140,065 in purse earnings.

"He is just a nice, consistent horse," said MacIntosh. "He can leave and do whatever you want with him. He had the one mistake, in the final of the Millard [Aug. 8 at Mohawk] where he broke stride, so we threw on the trotting hobbles after that. He's been very steady."

MacIntosh's other Million hopes rest on the hooves of Monalishi, a daughter of Green Manalishi S—Pretty Phylly G.

On Aug. 24 at Mohawk, with James MacDonald at the controls, Monalishi won in record fashion in a thrilling renewal of the \$390,000 Peaceful Way final.

Eighth of 10 through a half and on the move from sixth after three-quarters, the fleet-of-foot brown filly fired down the lane to post a half-length score in a track-record 1:52.2, propelled by a :27.4 final panel.

"She's not great on the front, even training down," said MacIntosh. "It was a sprint for home, and she put her nose down and dug in."

MacDonald said, "I said to Blake that she is so nice to drive. She just kind of rode lightly on the line the whole way and turning for home she was on the bit, but not raging. I said, 'Maybe, we will get a chunk.' Every time I asked her, she just gave me a little more and a little more, and then halfway down the lane, she really kicked into gear. I was pretty confident she was going to get there."



Monalishi eked out a nose nod in the Champlain Stakes on Sept. 13, a wire-to-wire score in 1:54.4.

While the late-race dramatics made for some nervous moments, seeing a resolute Monalishi emerge on top had MacIntosh beaming.

"You know that you have already purchased a slot for the Mohawk Million, and all you're thinking is, 'I don't want to lose going into it," he said. "But she wanted to win, and she got the job done."

A \$28,000 purchase at the 2023 Harrisburg Yearling Sale, Monalishi is 5-1-0 from seven starts.

The lone blemish on her record came when she broke stride in her first race, the Tompkins-Geers, on June 27.

"She has been a dream filly this year," MacIntosh said. "She has done everything we have asked her to do. She wants to win."

From July 11 to Aug. 5, Monalishi won three straight races, punctuated by striking gold in the \$150,000 Ontario Sires Stakes Gold final on that Monday evening last month.

MacIntosh, who co-owns with Tim Klemencic (Brad Grant was the original Mohawk Million slot owner), is hoping for another big-time performance in the Million.

"She is amazing, a horse that goes out there and gives it everything she has got," MacIntosh said. "She works hard every day."

Just like the man who watches over her and the others in his barn.

In a sport defined by numbers — payouts, purses, personal statistics, pacing and trotting miles, and more — MacIntosh himself is on the cusp of a notable five-figure mark, specifically, 10,000 training starts.

"At times, it feels like it has flown by quickly," he said. "When you have a down year, it feels like it is going slower. I hadn't realized we are coming up to that [milestone], that's a lot of starts."

It was 24 years ago when MacIntosh launched his training career.

His rookie season yielded a 3-2-1 line from 16 starts.

Prelude Semalu, a pacing son of Ships Purser (QC)—Semalu Crossing, gave MacIntosh his first training triumph.

The nine-length victory came on Dec. 10, 2020, in race 14 at Windsor Raceway.

There have been many more highlights since that \$5,500 dash with Mark MacDonald in the race bike.

In 2019, MacIntosh reached 100 wins (102) for the first time and recorded \$2 million in purse earnings for the second straight campaign.

Those two seasons were headlined by the numerous Grand Circuit feats of Courtly Choice, including wins in the Meadowlands Pace, Little Brown Juq and Canadian Pacing Derby.



Five years later, MacIntosh is on pace to have his most successful year. The stable has 87 wins, to go along with \$2,730,668 in purse earnings (less than \$40,000 away from setting a new standard), as of Sept. 18.

"It means a lot to our team," he said. "We had a couple of down seasons the past couple years, where we struggled to get the right horses in the barn, but everything has fallen into place this year. We've got a lot of great help. Ashlee Sluggett is running the barn in New York and Clayton Miller is my assistant up here, who both do a great job. To have people like that in charge helps a lot."

MacIntosh, as he always has, will continue to look ahead and not back.

At least for now.

On Wednesday, he was in Ohio to watch his bay filly, A Few Choice Words, a daughter of Courtly Choice—Top Choice Hanover, finish second in both her elimination and final of the 54th Jugette.

Soon, his thoughts will turn to Saturday evening and the night that awaits his rising-star rookies.

With a pair of chances, good ones, to step into the Mohawk Million winner's circle, MacIntosh is looking for his young trotting twosome to be at the top of their respective games.

"I'm okay right now; there is so much to focus on in the here and now," he said. "But I imagine [tonight] I will be thinking about it all night and hoping everything goes right.

"We just hope we can get the job done and that one can win and the other races well. That's all we can hope for."

Consistent 'Cookie' stepping up in Kentuckiana

Tonight (Sept. 20), Loveyoucookie will line up behind the Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino starting gate in the \$185,000 Kentuckiana Stallion Management Stake for freshman pacing fillies. This summer the Capt Midnight—Bluebird Love 2-year-old has hit the board in seven of eight starts. That's an accomplishment for the Doug Overhiser-owned pacer after she got off to a late start last winter.

"This will be a big test and she drew terribly," trainer Jamie Macomber said of the outside post position in the nine-filly field. "I think she'll be very consistent and be right there with them. She loves to race. She hasn't finished worse than fourth yet, and I don't expect that to change."

Today the expectations are high. But there was a time when Macomber and Overhiser had to temper their hopes for the filly. Purchased at last year's Hoosier Classic sale for \$30,000,

Loveyoucookie was cataloged with the name Bluebird Pdq, and sold later in the first day's session. She is from the first crop of Captaintreacherous son Capt Midnight. The filly is the first foal from Bluebird Love, a full-sister to \$200,000 winner Peter Dalt, a horse Macomber trained.

"Doug doesn't mind trying a new stallion if the price is right," Macomber said. "He and I picked her out and got her."

Loveyoucookie's transition into the Macomber barn didn't begin as anticipated. The filly missed several weeks of training after osteochondritis dissecans (OCDs) were found in both hind ankles, requiring surgery.

"I didn't get to sit behind her for a while," the conditioner said. "She had surgery and time off. She was at least six weeks behind my other babies."

When Loveyoucookie was ready to train, Macomber placed her in the slower set of developing pacers. The freshman quickly began to make up for lost time.

"She was catching up with them a little too quickly, so I stopped with her a little bit and took my time," Macomber said. "The next thing you know she was right back caught up with them again. She was perfect from day one. She never did anything wrong and kept pushing right through everything. Before we qualified, she was training in the good set."

After two winning qualifiers in June, Loveyoucookie made her pari-mutuel debut at Harrah's Hoosier Park on July 3. Steered by Ricky Macomber, Jr., the freshman took control after the quarter and won by half a length in a time of 1:56.3. She returned a week later to score in the opening round of Indiana Sires Stakes competition, winning by nearly three lengths with a 1:53.4 clocking. 'Cookie' as she is known around the barn, has added two more sires stakes runner-up performances and a show placing.


In Grand Circuit action at the Indiana State Fair, Loveyoucookie raced second to Papi Grad, timed in 1:52.1 with a 25-second last quarter.

"She's consistent," Jamie said. "I can count on her. She never has a bad day. She's had a great year, especially when you start off having surgery on both back ankles. You always hope they recover from that. Not only did she recover, but she's as good as can be."

Loveyoucookie enters tonight's Kentuckiana Stallion Management Stake after her worst performance of the season. Racing in the fifth leg of ISS action last week, the filly missed the board for the first time, crossing the wire fourth. Jamie noted that the young pacer had scoped sick after an Aug. 28 contest and that the most recent effort came as she was bouncing back from the ailment.

"She trained super this week," she said. "She seems sharp."

The Sept. 13 start was also the first with Dexter Dunn in the sulky. The adjustment was strategic for the Macomber Stable.


With stablemate JK's Flirty Girl on course to qualify for the Indiana Sires Stakes Super Final in October, another reinsman was needed for Loveyoucookie, currently second in points. Dunn was in town to drive in the Peter Haughton and Jim Doherty Memorials, sweeping both.


"We knew we would need a driver in the final for Cookie," Jamie said. "We own part of the other filly, so Ricky has to drive her. We took the opportunity last week with Dexter being here and knowing he would be here [tonight]. At least get him in one leg, the Kentuckiana, and the Super Final. Whether he can drive her the last leg of sires stakes, we'll see. We knew we would need a driver, so why not let him meet her now and get used to her before he goes for \$250,000."

The model of consistency has a 2-3-2 record from eight starts, with earnings of \$85,195. She is the richest and fastest of Capt Midnight's first crop thus far, and can add more in tonight's fifth race, slated for 7:33 p.m. Loveyoucookie is 12-1 on the morning line in a field that includes Heart Song (1:52.1s, 6-1), Beckoning Yankee (1:54.4f, 9-5), Always Ana Hanover (1:54.1f, 2-1) and Sammy Jo Hanover (1:55.1f, 5-1).

Today's Hoosier Park card is headlined by the \$200,000 Caesars Trotting Classic and \$165,000 Harrah's Hoosier Park Pacing Derby. Nearly \$1.4 million in purses are up for grabs over the 15-race program which kicks off with a 6 p.m. first post.









Periculum headlines \$200,000 Caesars Trotting Classic field at Harrah's Hoosier Park

The fields were drawn Tuesday (Sept. 17) for two of Harrah's Hoosier Park's signature events, the \$165,000 Harrah's Hoosier Park Pacing Derby, and \$200,000 Caesars Trotting Classic presented by Kountry Lane Standardbreds tonight (Sept. 20). Two full fields of 10 will go postward, with Periculum tabbed as the morning-line favorite in the Caesars Trotting Classic, and Little Rocket Man the presumptive bettors' choice in the Pacing Derby.

With combined earnings of over \$11 million and 186 wins, the Maple Leaf Trot champion Periculum headlines the powerhouse field of free-for-all trotters. Entering with a runner-up finish to Jiggy Jog S in the \$1,000,000 International Trot in his last outing, Periculum has won six of 11 on the season while banking \$543,522 for trainer Marcus Melander. Periculum leaves from post 4 with Scott Zeron listed to drive, right next to his Melander stablemate Oh Well, who leaves from post 3 as the 5-1 fourth choice.

Looking to join Bella Bellini as only the second mare to win the Caesars Trotting Classic, M-M's Dream returns to her Indiana roots, leaving from the second-tier in post 10 with Hall of Famer Tim Tetrick listed to drive. A 31-time winner in 48 career outings, M-M's Dream was an Indiana Sire Stakes champion at 2 and 3 before branching out in her older campaign, banking \$1,699,417 and taking a career mark of 1:50 at The Meadowlands in 2023. M-M's Dream returns to the Herny Graber, Jr. barn tonight for owners Eleven Star Stable, Frank Baldachino and Hillside Stables.

Trainer Ron Burke sends a pair of entries in the Trotting Classic, including 2023 champion, It's Academic. The career earner of \$2.5 million won last year's edition in a stakes record time of 1:50.3. It's Academic leaves from the rail at 15-1 with Dave Miller aboard as he was for last year's victory. Right next door in post 2 from the Burke Brigade is Hambletonian Maturity champion, Chapercraz with Yannick Gingras listed to drive at 6-1 on the morning line.

The \$165,000 Harrah's Hoosier Park Pacing Derby sees a field of 10 headlined by the last two champions of the Little Brown Jug, seven millionaires and the 2024 Dan Patch champion, Dunkin'. A total of 15 horses entered this year's Pacing Derby, including supplemental entry, Backstreet Shadow. The top-nine career money earners along with Dunkin', due to his victory in the \$300,000 Dan Patch Stakes, secured their spot in tonight's field.

Hometown hero Little Rocket Man is slated as the morning line choice, with "The Buckeye" David Miller listed to drive for trainer Ken Rucker. Now 8, Little Rocket Man is on track for a career year, with victories already in the Battle of Lake Erie at Northfield and in the Jim Ewart Memorial in his last outing at Scioto Downs. A winner in 10 of 13 this season, the 64-time winner sports career earnings of \$1,462,299 for owners Russ Beeman and Boomer Freeman.

Last year's Little Brown Jug champion, It's My Show enters in fine form, a winner in the Canadian Pacing Derby two back before backing it up with a 1:49.2 Kentucky Sire Stakes score at The Red Mile in his last outing. Linda Toscano trains the royally bred 4-year-old son of Sweet Lou—Put On A Show who has made \$1,486,502 lifetime.

The horse It's My Show tracked down in the Canadian Pacing Derby, Abuckabett Hanover, is the 7-2 second-choice for trainer Andrew Harris. The 6-year-old son of Betting Line already has wins in the Dave Brower and William Haughton Memorials at The Meadowlands this year with Dexter Dunn listed to drive. Dunn swept the Peter Haughton and Jim Doherty Memorials last Friday at Harrah's Hoosier Park.

Monica Sutherland's fledgling career is starting to surge

The pride of Port Hood is keeping her wheels in motion.

A picturesque seaside community nestled on the West coast of Cape Breton Island, and the capital of Inverness County, NS, Port Hood is home to roughly 1,300 inhabitants, and the hometown of Maritimes horsewoman Monica Sutherland.

In the early stages of her driving career -2023 was her rookie campaign in the race bike - the personable 24-year-old has already made a name for herself competing on Canada's east

"My main goal is to just keep improving and getting better at what I do," she told HRU. "You learn a little something new every day. I want to take all that and try to be the best I can be."

Sutherland, who drove in the Nova Scotia amateur ranks ahead of her debut, a third, on May 28, 2023, at Inverness Raceway, enjoyed a banner first season in the race bike.

There were several highlights to speak of, including her milestone first win, the victory coming courtesy of Eastcoast Ms Haney, a daughter of Arthur Blue Chip—Manhattan Delight, who she trains for her father, Todd Sutherland.

The win, on June 11, did not come without some late-race dramatics.

In fact, it took a photo finish to decide whose nose hit the wire first in the opening dash that Sunday.

Initially, Sutherland didn't think she was the winner.

"I wasn't too sure," she said. "Coming through the stretch, she was rolling, but I thought we would get second or third. My dad told me he thought we got it, so when we did, it was a great feeling."

The day would prove to be twice as nice for Sutherland.

Five races after the dramatic score, Eastcoast Invader, a bay son of Rollwithitharry—Manhattan Delight who she trains and co-owns with her father, pulled off the 16-1upset.

This time, however, there was no doubt who had won.

"We opened up in that one and didn't have to worry that time," said Sutherland, of the 2½-length win that produced a \$34.30 win ticket. "It was a big effort from the horse. So, winning a close one and then an easier one made for an interesting day."

The biggest moment of her first driving season came on Aug. 26. Again, it came with Eastcoast Ms Haney.

Sutherland and the slight 9-5 choice were at North Sides Downs — a half-mile track in North Sydney, Nova Scotia — for an Atlantic Sires Stakes B Division dash.

A length and a half behind leader Weather The Storm at the three-quarter pole, Eastcoast Ms Haney and Sutherland worked

overtime to eke out the narrowest of wins, crossing the line a nose in front.

"Another close one," she said with a laugh. "I didn't think I got that one either. It was by a hair. That was an amazing moment, and it was so nice to be able to share that with my family. We named her after my grandfather, so that is another reason why it was so meaningful for us.

"We had five wins together last year and this horse has helped me so much. To get that first stakes win with her was extra special."

By year's end, there were 20 wins and 56 top three finishes to Sutherland's name.

Sutherland, who launched the training side of her standardbred life in 2020, had also posted a career high 11 training wins and 34 top three results from 55 starts.

Recently, she reached the 200-drive mark.

"I never expected any of this," said Sutherland, whose great uncle, Alex Sutherland, owns and trains several of Todd Sutherland's horses. "It has been so much better than I believed it would be."

Her approach to the sport has been shaped by many, including her father.

Advice has been plentiful and welcomed.

"It's important to pay attention in this sport, to listen to helpful words, and to keep an open mind," Monica said. "There is always something you can take and put into what you do.

"The support I have had, both in racing and in my life, has been amazing. My family is always there for me, and it helps with your confidence. I feel very fortunate."

A short memory has also helped Monica succeed.

"Whether you win or lose, you can't dwell on what happened in the race before," she said. "You have to stay within the moment. You never want to get too high or too low. You just need to be prepared for the next one."

Which is why Monica is meticulously prepared ahead of each card.

"I do quite a bit of homework, studying the program, looking at what could possibly happen," she said. "But no matter how you prepare, once the race starts, things rarely go to plan. You try to play it out in your head, but that's not how it typically goes. You have to be able to adapt in a split second."

As for goals, both present and future, Monica is looking to add some horses to her barn and more wins to her stat sheet.

"This year, I haven't had as many wins as I did last year," she said. "But we have been consistent, getting a lot of seconds and thirds, so there is always reason to be optimistic. I am getting more opportunities to drive, which has been nice. I would like to get on a roll and get some more wins.

"I am training three horses right now, so down the road, I would like to add a few more. It's nice when you can drive your own horses because of that familiarity – you know everything about them. But overall, I am very happy with where we are."

When she isn't in the race bike or in the paddocks and shedrows, Monica is hard at work as an electrician.

She learned the skill from her grandfather.

"I am doing my apprenticeship," she said. "It's something I really enjoy. With that and the horses, it definitely keeps me busy throughout the year. I don't have much time for anything else. Horse racing, it might be a hobby, but it is a full-time job, but that's okay with me."

As to where her horse racing life will lead, Monica, much like she approaches each race, will be prepared for wherever it might take her.

For now, there is no place like home.

"I just want to keep improving and see what happens," she said. "You never know where it will lead, but I'm excited to find out."

Kings County to stand in Minnesota

Kings County 2,1:52.3, 1:51.4f (\$523,066) has been retired and will stand his first season in 2025. The trotter will stand at Bluff Country Equine in Minnesota. He represents his sire as the richest and fastest son of Muscle Hill to stand in the state.

Racing for Lindy Farms early in his career, he was a stakes winner at 2, winning the International Stallion Stake and the Champlain. Although an injury prevented his sophomore season from happening, he proved his resilience as an older trotter. Racing for much of his older career for Anthony MacDonald and Thestable.ca, the trotter held track records in Ohio at both Scioto Downs and Dayton Raceway, and currently is the co-track record holder at The Meadows as the fastest older stallion trotter.

The former \$210,000 yearling sets the bar high in the growing Minnesota program. Perhaps as impressive as his record and earnings is the Kings County pedigree page. By Muscle Hill, the sire of winners of over \$108 million, he's from the Conway Hall mare Brooklyn. The mare's Muscle Hill full brother to Kings County was the highest priced yearling at Harrisburg in 2023, fetching \$600,000.

MacDonald had this to say about the new stallion, "He was a killer for us forever. Kings County was all class and never seemed to get tired. His full brother sold for \$600,000 last fall, so he's a winner from a family of winners. He set multiple track records and I couldn't be more excited about what he will mean for the Minnesota breeding program."

Owner Jeff Fought with Cornerstone Stock Farm said, "Minnesota has been great to our farm over the past two seasons with our pacing stallion Gulf Shores. He's bred record books in the state each year so far, so the search has been on for a trotting stallion of the same caliber. Kings County checks the boxes, a fast 2-year-old, a fast [older] horse, a stakes winner, a huge pedigree and by a sire of sires."

A \$40,000 King of Minnesota Bonus Program will be available to those that breed to Kings County. For mares bred to the stallion in 2025 (2026 foals), a \$20,000 bonus will be paid to the breeder if a Kings County offspring wins a Minnesota Harness Racing (MHRI) freshman divisional championship in 2028 (two separate awards available for colts and fillies in the trotting division).

A fertility test was recently conducted and Kings County was approved for a full book. He will stand at Minnesota's premier breeding facility, Bluff Country Equine, for a fee of \$2,000, or \$1,750 for multiple mares. Foals will be Minnesota and California eligible, as well as eligible for Breeders' Crown nomination. Contact Jeff Fought with Cornerstone Stock Farm at 260-463-1649 for more information.

Allywag Hanover retired

Allywag Hanover, one of North America's greatest racehorses, has been retired from racing.

A multiple world record holder, Allywag Hanover started 79 times during his career, winning 28 races and placing in 49 of them.

Allywag Hanover was voted the Dan Patch Award winner as the best older pacer in 2021. During that year he became the fastest 4-year-old gelding in the history of The Red Mile when he stopped the timer in 1:46.4 during the Allerage Farms open pace. His career continued with another record on a five-eighths-mile track when he won the Potomac Pace at Rosecroft in 2022, again in 1:46.4.

Perhaps Allywag Hanover's most well-known feat is when he upset Bulldog Hanover in the Allerage Farms open pace at The Red Mile in a world record (for a gelding) 1:46.

At the time, trainer Brett Pelling had this to say about him: "He's a beast. People don't give him the kudos that he deserves. When you're around him, trust me, he gives you chills. You have no idea how fast he is traveling, and he's got a very unique way of going, and it's just plain fast. And it's a different kind of speed. It's raw."

The partners want to thank Brett Pelling, driver Todd McCarthy and groom Terry Buchanan for all their hard work.

"We want to thank everyone who has followed, watched, and cheered on Allywag over the last six years," said racing manager Marcus Johansson, representing Allywag Partners. "He has provided some of the greatest moments of racing for both us as owners and the sport as a whole."

The now 7-year-old gelding will have a forever home at Diamond Creek. He will be turned out and rehabbed, and then it will be determined what he wants to do next, whether it's a second career as a riding horse, an equine ambassador, or just enjoying life as a pasture pet.
