# **Gut-Check**

Courtly Choice won the 73rd Little
Brown Jug on Thursday at the Delaware
County Fairgrounds in Ohio with a
performance as gutsy as the connections
that wrote massive supplement checks
to get him there.

Courtly Choice (David Miller) just got up in the final strides to defeat Dorsoduro Hanover and Lather Up.

When Courtly Choice broke stride behind the starting gate Thursday afternoon in his Little Brown Jug heat, driver David Miller said his heart immediately plunged to the bottom of his stomach.

"I was so sick when he ran behind the gate. Coming here today I thought he could win and there he was running behind the gate," Miller said.

Courtly Choice's trainer and part-owner Blake MacIntosh was experiencing similar gut-rot, his anguish amplified by the fact he and his partners put up \$45,000 to supplement Courtly Choice to the 73rd Jug.

"It was heartwrenching," MacIntosh said. "You've put \$45,000 in and I'm thinking 'the poor owners,' not just myself, but the poor owners."

So, when Courtly Choice not only made a massive three-wide recovery to finish third-placed-second — more on that in a second — and qualify for the final, you can just imagine the relief in Camp Courtly.

"When he pulled him three-wide down the backside and made that move I was, like, 'He's a beast...' That was probably the biggest move I've seen a horse do. That doesn't happen here. He overcame me and he overcame the break, it's unreal," MacIntosh said.

Now imagine how big the smiles were after the colt won the final in thrilling fashion in the last strides after coming first up on impressive first heat winner Lather Up.

Arriving in the winner's circle on the back of a golf cart loaded down with excited connections, MacIntosh hopped off and yelled, "Un-f---ing real. Excuse the language, I'm going to swear, I don't care," he said, laughing, before bursting through the hedges at the back of the charmed circle and into the Jug limelight where Roger Huston was waiting.

Later, MacIntosh snuck behind Miller and gave him a big, sloppy kiss on the cheek as a way of telling the driver all was forgiven for the earlier miscue.

In his heat, Courtly Choice made a costly break at the gate, but recovered to finished third-placed-second.

"That was a big weight off," Miller said of Courtly Choice's dramatic victory, not MacIntosh's kiss.

It wasn't easy. Lather Up (Montrell Teague) was in control of the \$436,560 final from the start, blasting out of the two hole to the front and leading until the very last steps when he was overcome by both Courtly Choice and Dorsoduro Hanover, who finished a neck back in second. Lather Up held on for third. The mile was 1:49.4.

Miller said it wasn't until "the last 20 yards" that he knew he had won his record-tying fifth Little Brown Jug.

"I saw he was getting up and I couldn't be happier. I was

pushing on him pretty hard and he was still digging. I was pretty excited when I hit the wire," Miller said.

MacIntosh said it wasn't ideal for Courtly Choice to come first up, "but I knew he would grind. I know he wouldn't give up. He's got the heart of a lion and he's just unreal." He added that he knew Courtly Choice got the job done "about two feet after the wire."

Then, fireworks exploded in his head. It is his first Jug victory.

"I was thinking, 'Wow, we won the Little Brown Jug.' It's just something that's unreal. You dream of winning... for me, it's

three races, the North America Cup – that's my home track and I want to win that badly – the Meadowlands Pace and Little Brown Jug," MacIntosh said.

Considering Courtly Choice won the Meadowlands Pace earlier this year, it's two down and one to go for the trainer. None of it would have been possible without a gutsy horse and even gutsier connections.

### A mere \$140,000, if you please

The Little Brown Jug was the third race Courtly Choice has been supplemented to this year by his mostly Canadian



connections — Hutt Racing Stable (Joe and JoAnn Thomson of Pennsylvania of Winbak fame), Mac & Heim Stables (MacIntosh and Steve Heimbecker) of Ontario, Daniel Plouffe of Quebec and Touch Stone Farms (Barb & Joe Intine) of Ontario. First it was some \$60,000 to supplement to the Meadowlands Pace, a gamble that clearly paid off. Then, they paid \$35,000 to supplement to the Cane Pace where Courtly Choice was fourth to Stay Hungry. Finally, it was another \$45,000 to supplement to the Jug, a move only made possible by winning the Meadowlands Pace. That's some \$140,000 in supplement payments.

Asked why the group was willing to write so many big checks, MacIntosh was candid.

"Because I'm not going to have another one this good, so the owners are game for it and we wanted to try to increase his value as a stud," the trainer said. "He's bred well. He's got a millionaire brother and he's close to a million now, probably \$900,000. His brother is Betterthancheddar and he's starting to show that he's a good stud so we wanted to make sure that people knew (Courtly Choice) was a good horse."

Plouffe, who won the 1999 Jug as owner of Blissfull Hall, said he had no problem making the investment because Courtly Choice is, "good. He's really good. And Blake does a really good job with him, taking good care of him and races him at just the right time."

As for Joe Thomson of Winbak Farms, who doubles as the breeder of Courtly Choice, he laughed when asked about being part of the decision to supplement.

"They generally don't even call me up, they just say 'he's in," Thomson said.

The Jug triumph improved Courtly Choice to 10-1-0 in 14 starts this year and earnings of \$899,353. Lifetime, the Art Major colt out of Lady Ashlee Ann, is 12-2-0 in 26 starts and sports earnings of \$952,704.

### Tale of two wildly different heats

The two \$102,720 Jug heats could not have been more different.

In the first heat, Lather Up went to the front out of the rail position and cruised to a gate-to-wire, one-and-a-half length victory in 1:49.3. The field finished in exact post position order 1 through 7.

In the second heat, chaos ensured. After favored Courtly Choice broke stride just before the gate opened, second choice Stay Hungry (Doug McNair) took command and paced first to the wire, but was disqualified for interference near the three-quarter pole. Dorsoduro Hanover (Matt Kakaley) finished three-quarters-of-a-length back in second and was subsequently elevated to first in a race. Judges also looked at whether Stay Hungry went inside pylons in the stretch — the video clearly shows he went inside at least two pylons — but





chose to set the horse back to fourth for interference. Stay Hungry drew the eight hole, but was scratched, bringing an end to the Tony Alagna trainee's pacing Triple Crown bid.

Between Courtly Choice's heat and the final, MacIntosh made some equipment changes.

"We took the Murphy blind off him, because he was running out a little bit on Dave. Usually, he gets on the right line. Today, Dave said 'he was as sound as he's ever been for

me.' Dave wanted the Murphy blind off, so I took it off," the trainer said.

It certainly helped in the final, the driver said.

### Many Jug firsts

The result was the first Jug victory for MacIntosh, Steve Heimbecker, Barb and Joe Intine and Joe and JoAnn Thomson (as owners). It was the third Jug victory for the Thomsons as breeders. Winbak Farms also produced Jug winners Bettor's Delight and No Pan Intended.

"It's more fun to be an owner, but there's a lot of pride being the breeder," Joe Thomson said. "It also disproves the old mare theory. (Courtly Choice's dam, Lady Ashlee Ann was like 22 years old and died having him. (The dam) was named after my daughter, so all of that is good stuff," The Jug was the second for Plouffe, who owned Blissfull Hall.

"You know, I told my wife today, 'When you can win the Jug one time in your life, it's amazing, but the second win, I don't know.' Winning the Jug in 1999 and to be here today winning the Jug again... and Blissfull Hall being in the Hall of Fame, it's wonderful," Plouffe said.

For Miller, his fifth Jug victory ties him with Mike Lachance and Billy Haughton for most driving victories. Miller said the sensation never gets old.

"It feels just like the first time, baby," Miller said, grinning,

while clutching a single yellow rose left over from the bucketful he handed out to some of the 46,126 in attendance at the Delaware County Fairgrounds.

Asked what he loves most about Courtly Choice, Blake MacIntosh didn't hesitate.

"His heart, his heart. He's just all heart. We'll go back (to the Jug Barn) now and he'll just be sitting there with his head out looking for his licorice," MacIntosh said.

Twenty minutes later, that prophecy came true. As happy connections milled around him, Courtly Choice munched licorice and posed for countless photos with a look that suggested he didn't know what all the fuss was all about.

I'm Your Captain (Andy Miller) used a four-wide move around the final turn to defeat Hill Street (Yannick Gingras) and Maxus (Jimmy Takter) to take the Old Oaken Bucket in 1:55.2. The pacesetting Treasure Tee (Trevor Henry) faded to fourth.

I'm You Captain is owned by Andy Miller Stable and Black Horse Racing and trained by Julie Miller.

The Muscle Hill colt has won four out his last seven starts.

### \$107,000 Ms. Versatility Trot Final

David Miller and Broadway Donna used a perfect second over trip and defeated NF Happenstance (Jack Parker, Jr.) by 1 1/4 lengths in 1:53.1. Ice Attraction (Yannick Gingras) was third, another two lengths behind.

Broadway Donna is trained by Jim Campbell and has amassed \$1.4 million for Fashion Farms.

The second \$55,777 division went to the heavily favored Bounding Dragon and Dan Noble in 1:51.

The winner went gate to wire for owners Alan Keith and Melanie Atley and trainer Mike Roth. The ultra-consistent Bounding Dragon has finished in the top two places eleven times this season.

# Fans flock to Foiled Again Farewell stop at the Jug

As the crowd of phone-wielding amateur photographers began to swell around Foiled Again in the Jug Barn on Thursday morning at the Delaware County Fairgrounds, the horse's trainer and part-owner Ron Burke couldn't help but smile at the reception at this, his latest stop on the Foiled Again Farewell Tour.

"It's been incredible. It's been like this in every place," Burke said. "It's just more people than you can imagine appreciating him. The thing is, the horse really appreciates it. I'd say a year ago that maybe he wouldn't have done this, but he's got the idea of how special this is and he really seems to enjoy the attention and hangs out. It's nice."

Foiled Again, the richest standardbred in history with earnings of \$7.59 million, greeted fans and then led the post parade for the Little Brown Juq.

"Yesterday they gave him a standing ovation in the tent when he pulled up and I thought, 'This is cool'. It was really neat, really awesome, so I think it's really nice," Burke said. "For sure, it's been the highlight of the year. It's just made it a completely different experience. Usually everything is stressful, but there's no stress to this, it's just pure enjoyment."

Booked for appearances across North America for the rest of the year, Foiled Again's racing career will culminate at his home track, The Meadows, on New Year's Eve, the last day the 14-year-old son of Dragon Again—In A Safe Place can race before facing mandatory retirement when he turns 15 on Jan. 1.

"I realize any time that I do one of these that it's that much closer to the end for him, with him, and that's tough to take," Burke said. "My whole family is emotional and I know (the last race) will get crazy."

# What is it about the Jug that gives people a buzz?

Buzzworthy was at this year's Little Brown Jug and I went around asking industry participants and racing fans what it is about the Jug that gives them a buzz. There was a common theme that developed. Here is a sampling of the responses:

**Stay Hungry driver Doug McNair** – "It's a great atmosphere; lots of people are here, it's a really good party, and it's a great race. I think it's my favorite race and I always wanted to win it. It's just nice to be in it and have a legit shot."

Adriano Sorella, owner of 2013 Little Brown Jug winner Vegas Vacation — "The old time feel it has. It really does feel like you're at a fair, where anyone and everyone line up to watch, and in the end your racing for some serious money and prestige."

**Little Brown Publicity Director Jay Wolf** — "Obviously, 73 years of tradition is hard to ignore," he said. "I'm just happy to follow Wil Kilburger and the legendary Tom White and carry on their tradition."

Harness Racing Museum and Hall of Fame Marketing Director Chris Tully — "For me, it's the fans and their enthusiasm."

**Photographer and racing fan Ryan Dickey** — "It's the pre-eminent race of the year, so, why not be here"?

**USTA social media director Michael Carter** – "I've said it before; fair racing brings on a totally different atmosphere. Racing right in the middle of the fair with the fair food and the excitement of the fans who are right on top of the action is awesome. Fair racing is

just great."

Hall of Fame communicator Gordon Waterstone – "The whole atmosphere of the day with all of the people surrounding the track with the chairs lined up permanently for people that come every year. It's the whole atmosphere: the double heat race and the excitement and fun of the surroundings. It's a long day, but it's a great day."

Mohawk Park track announcer Ken Middleton – "I think it's the crowd more than anything. We don't see that very much at all even at some of our major events. Yeah, it's the crowd."

Wes Delight/Decoy Driver Yannick Gingras – "The crowd, no doubt. That's what you come here for and it's different from the day-to-day races at every other racetrack; it's a bigger crowd, they're right on top of you all the way around the racetrack. That's what makes the Jug so special."

Stay Hungry trainer Tony Alagna – "Just the atmosphere. You know it kind of gives us all a little bit of hope that there are true harness racing fans still around that like to see great horses race. You come here, and you feel that energy. You pull into the gate on Jug day and the energy is incredible. To see this many true harness racing fans gives you hope that the industry still has some life left in it."

Hambletonian president and CEO John Campbell – "Just the closeness of the crowd to the track. It's the atmosphere and the electricity that comes off the crowd."

Railbird Harry Watson, who has been to the Jug for the last "10 or 12 years" – "The half-mile track, the aggressive driving and the people."

For me, it's all of that and more. It's about making memories with my son Nicholas (Ace). It's about the food – especially the Der Dutchman banana cream pie. It's about meeting up with and spending time with friends within the industry. But mostly it's about what I love doing most – watching, betting on, writing about and enjoying harness racing on one of its greatest stages.





# Having to pay the 15-second tax means harness racing is alive and well

This past weekend, two young NFL kickers, Daniel Carlson and Zane Gonzalez of the Vikings and Browns, respectively, felt the wrath of the fans and sports media after missing an array of game saving or winning kicks. The chatter was so intense you'd think TMZ released video of them knocking off a set of liquor stores.

This is something we see often in sports and society – human beings doing their best, failing, and fans reducing them to a caricature. If we're honest with ourselves, I think most of us partake in it from time to time. It's human nature.

Tennis player Andre Agassi has written and spoken about this phenomenon. He believes the price of stardom (and his ability to cash nice sized paychecks) involves a "tax", whereby each fan is owed at least 15 seconds of his time. These fans can be cordial, and he happily gives them time or an autograph to say thank you; they can be nasty, and he has to read it written, shouted from the stands, or in the very worst cases hear it in person on the street, or in bars or restaurants.

One might think harness racing participants – trainers, drivers – do not have to pay this tax because it's such a small sport. But I'm not sure that's the case.

Harness racing draws about \$2 billion in wagering a year from the general public. In comparison, the NFL receives about \$8 billion in revenues, and in hockey, NHL players make about \$2 billion. We all realize that those two mainstream sports dwarf harness racing in popularity, but the simple fact is, big money is flowing through the turnstiles, as well as the betting windows.

So, when equipment changes were made on Swandre the


Giant last week for the Canadian Trotting Classic, and world-class trainer Jimmy Takter is called something not too nice in the grandstand after the colt fails, it's just the way it is.

It matters not that Jimmy and his capable team had the horse looking much better on the turns than the previous week, and he's a top trainer who knows what he's doing. It only matters that that fan lost the \$50 he or she wagered, and they're expressing themselves in the only way they can. Jimmy (already no doubt in a sour mood because his colt was sitting perfectly and busted) still has to pay the tax.

On the good side, paying the tax to fans who express themselves in positive ways is something that I don't think should be lost either. Woodbine Entertainment driver Jody Jamieson seems to get this concept in spades.

After a win, time after time, Jody walks his horse along the rail where fans (most of them young) can get close to the horse, or give him a high five for the win. It's done on purpose — it's the "15 seconds" he believes he owes — and this simple gesture can make someone's day.

On social media, the "15 seconds" can seem cumbersome, because, well, it's nameless, faceless (often times horrible)



social media. But it's easy to ignore the bad stuff and spend 15 seconds on the good. The ever-personable Corey Callahan exemplified that just this weekend after one of his big Kentucky Sires Stakes wins:



It took Corey just a second to acknowledge a nice comment. And it's the right thing to do.

Although most of us consider harness racing a small sport, dominated by insiders, there's a whole world out there watching it. And we should be happy they are. When there's no one to give 15 seconds to, harness racing's days as a sport are over.

# Fox Valley Gemini looks to settle score Saturday in Illinois

The 3-year-old pacer's only two losses in a stellar 19-race career have come in his home state to You'remyhearthrob. Saturday, during Hawthorne Race Course's Night of Champions, the two pacers will square off again on a gangbuster's card featuring purses exceeding \$1.1 million.

Before Fox Valley Gemini hits the road for Indiana, where he will embark on a campaign to attain national prominence, the reigning Illinois Horse of the Year has a score to settle on the home front.

Hawthorne Race Course's Night of Champions for state-breds is the main event on the Illinois racing calendar and the most riveting of the 11 championship races on Saturday night's program is the \$160,080 Robert F. Carey Memorial for 3-year-old pacers in which Fox Valley Gemini will attempt to avenge the only two losses of his 19-race career.

They came in August at Springfield — a second in the Illinois State Fair Colt Stakes elimination and a fourth in the final — and both were at the heels of You'remyhearthrob, the most menacing of his nine opponents in the Carey Memorial.

Casey Leonard, who has driven Fox Valley Gemini in all of his races for 79-year-old owner Jim Ballinger, sensed something was wrong in the Colt Stakes final and he was right. When the gelding was scoped, the diagnosis was a viral infection.

Casey's 67-year-old father, Terry Leonard, trains Fox Valley Gemini and considers him one of the best horses he has conditioned in a career that spans more than four decades.

"He's just a natural athlete," said Terry, who then likened Fox Valley Gemini to two of Chicago's iconic athletes. "Walter Payton and Michael Jordan — when they weren't 100 per cent (physically) they weren't 100 per cent (athletically). Gemini is the same way. When he's healthy he refuses to get beat."

mare Epona some time to recuperate at his Rush Creek Farm after the out-of-character races in Springfield, then let him gradually work his way back to regular training.

On Sept. 6 Fox Valley Gemini returned to Hawthorne for a qualifying race that was his first outing following the Aug. 15 fourth-place finish in Springfield.

The result was a resounding 19 1/4-length victory in 1:55.2.

That performance assured driver and trainer that he again was ready for prime time, which in this instance was the fourth and last leg of the Carey Memorial eliminations on Sept. 14.

The defending champion Illinois Horse of the Year looked the part, delivering a decisive five-length victory in 1:51.1.

"He looked awfully good," Ballinger said. "If he races that well Saturday night I don't think the other horses can handle him."

Casey Leonard's critique: "I was happy with his performance. I'd put it among his best races."

It was a better performance than You'remyhearthrob's compelling conquest in the other Carey elimination. In rebounding from an Aug. 29 second at the DuQuoin State Fair that followed his two big races at Springfield, the gelding trained by Brett Wilfong and driven by his son, Kyle Wilfong, won by 1 1/2 lengths in 1:52.3.

This will be the racing equivalent of baseball's "rubber game" because at Hawthorne in July, Fox Valley Gemini got the best of You'remyhearthrob in the two races that prefaced their Springfield



encounters, relegating him to second and then third.

While You'remyhearthrob seems to be obsessed with pacing on the front end, Fox Valley Gemini has proven to be equally effective on the lead or rallying from behind.

"He's very fleet of foot (and) he's very versatile," Casey Leonard said.

Last year on the Night of Champions, Fox Valley Gemini made his ninth and final 2018 start in the Incredible Finale for 2-year-old male pacers. Leaving from post 9, he was fifth at the quarter and sixth at the half-mile and three-quarters before surging to the lead and drawing off for a 3 ½-length triumph in 1:53.4.

This year, tentative plans call for Fox Valley Gemini to leave Illinois for the first time and compete in open company. The races for 3-year-olds that Terry Leonard has in mind are Hoosier Park's \$65,000 Circle City Pace on Oct. 26 and \$200,000 Monument Circle on Nov. 2.

Up to now, all of his races have been against other Illinois-breds at Hawthorne and Springfield.

"He's a very nice horse here in Illinois, but I don't know if he can go with the open horses," cautioned Casey Leonard. "Time will tell. We hope to find a prep race for him at Hoosier before the Circle City."

Regardless of how Fox Valley Gemini fares, he has vastly exceeded expectations.

His dam, Epona, raced for Ballinger and wasn't a high profile pacer. After she ended her career with earnings of \$63,311, Ballinger made a deal with Dr. Kenneth (Doc) Walker of Fox Valley Standardbreds, sending her to the breeder for a breeding fee. A few years later, Ballinger bought Fox Valley Gemini as a yearling from Walker for \$2,700 at the Fox Valley sale.

When Fox Valley Gemini came to Rush Creek Farm (after being broken and trained by Ballinger's son, Brett, at the Carrollton fair grounds) he showed some promise, but his workouts were hardly auspicious and when he went to Hawthorne for a qualifying race in mid-June he finished sixth.

Once he began competing in pari-mutuel races, it was a completely different story. In short order, he demonstrated that he was destined to become Illinois Horse of the Year.

While Fox Valley Gemini looks like he's on the brink of defending his championship, Casey Leonard already has won his second straight driver title at the summer meet by a landslide margin. Going into the final five nights of the Chicago sulky circuit's only meeting that will end Monday, he has 195 winners to 83 for second place Kyle Wilfong.

Meanwhile, Terry Leonard, who finished second in the trainer standings last year, has this year's championship locked up with 53 winners to 39 for runner-up Ronnie Roberts.

The Leonards have a strong candidate going for them again this year in the \$136,142 Incredible Finale. His name is The Bucket and the 2-year-old colt by Sagebrush out of the Cole Muffler mare

Chevie in Motion has seven wins, a place and two shows in 10 starts for owners Ken Rucker and George Dramonas.

In his final elimination leg The Bucket was third behind Meyer On Fire and Coming Up.


"He was a victim of the trip," Casey said. "I raced him hard (on the lead) the week before. This time I wanted to race him off the pace. There were extremely slow fractions and we got stacked up on the first turn. When he did move the pace had increased."

Casey is driving one of the night's most interesting horses, Loussolataire, in the \$122,504 Fox Valley Flan for 2-year-old filly trotters. Competing mainly at the fairs, Loussolataire has won 16 of her 31 starts for trainer Steven Searle and owner Steven Renard, making her the winningest 2-year-old in North America.

Leonard became her driver on Sept. 7 when she finished a stalking second in a leg of the Fox Valley Flan series and he was back in the sulky a week later when she took her elimination race, rallying along the rail to win at the wire.

"She's a nice little filly, very small, but she's a tough little horse," Leonard said. "Driving 2-year-old trotters can be challenging but she's very nice to drive.
