# Stranger stands Tall in the Metro

Undefeated Tall Dark Stranger delivered the first Metro win for trainer Nancy Johansson and driver Yannick Gingras with a 1:49.1 stakes record in the \$750,000 final.

Driver Yannick Gingras (with co-owner Marvin Katz and his wife Lynne in the background) celebrated his first victory in the Metro Pace after piloting Tall Dark Stranger to a 1:49.1 stakes record Saturday at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Undefeated rookie Tall Dark Stranger established a new stakes record with a 1:49.1 victory in Saturday's \$750,000 Metro Pace at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The son of Bettors Delight—Precocious Beauty angled from the two-hole and cruised home in :27, giving his driver Yannick Gingras and trainer Nancy Johansson each their first victory in harness racing's richest race for 2-year-olds.

"He's just a great colt," said Johansson. "He looked strong the whole way and still had his plugs in at the wire. If they were coming harder at him I think he still had some left in the tank."

Tall Dark Stranger equalled the 1:49.1 track record set by A Rocknroll Dance in 2011.


Tall Dark Stranger left from post-four and circled around Easi Hanover, who blasted from the outside to lead at the opening-quarter in :27. Race-favorite Capt Midnight moved out from third and went after the lead racing up the backstretch, getting stretched out by Tall Dark Stranger before clearing after a :54.1 half.

Capt Midnight carried the lead around the far turn with Tall Dark Stranger and Gingras angling from the two-hole ahead of the three-quarter pole. Ys Mathis was first-up, three-lengths from the lead, with Papi Rob Hanover on his back. The three-quarter time was 1:22.

In the stretch, Tall Dark Stranger powered by Capt Midnight to a clear lead with an eighth of a mile to go. Papi Rob Hanover made things interesting late, ultimately coming up half a length short to a steady Tall Dark Stranger. Capt Midnight finished third, while Seeyou At Thebeach was fourth.

Tall Dark Stranger grinded away to narrowly defeated Papi Rob Hanover in last week's elimination. Gingras felt that performance made a big impact on the colt.

"(Last week) it took (Tall Dark Stranger) a long time in the stretch, but today I stretched the other colt and in the last turn he knew what it was about this time," said Gingras. "When I came out of the two-hole he went right by Capt

It was the first Metro win for trainer Nancy Johansson.

Midnight and that was without even me asking him at that point.

"He's got some learning to do, but he's got all the tools to be a great one." Tall Dark Stranger is owned by Crawford Farms Racing, Marvin Katz, Caviart Farms and Howard Taylor. The colt, bred by Jim Avritt, Sr. of Lebanon, KY, is now six for six with \$499,533 earned after being purchased for \$330,000 at last October's Lexington Selected Yearling Sale.

The clocking of 1:49.1 shaved a fifth of a second off the previous stakes record set by Sportswriter in 2009. It also matches the track record set by A Rocknroll Dance in 2011.

Gingras and Johansson can now scratch the Metro Pace off their bucket list, as the duo teamed up in the 2011 edition to finish second with Western Vintage.

Johansson's victory with Tall Dark Stranger gives her a sweep of Mohawk Park's two richest races of the season, as she captured the \$1 million Pepsi North America Cup in June with Captain Crunch.

"Not bad for a girl born in Sweden," said Johansson, laughing. "I'm very lucky that I have owners that support me with great horses and makes my job a lot easier having the material to perform at the highest level."

Tall Dark Stranger paid \$5.40 to win.

# Lyons Sentinel sets Canadian record in Shes A Great Lady

Her 1:49.3 victory was orchestrated by Tim Tetrick for trainer Jim King, Jr.

Lyons Sentinel entered the Canadian harness racing record books with a stunning 1:49.3 victory in Saturday's \$540,000 Shes A Great Lady for 2-year-old pacing fillies at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The daughter of Captaintreacherous—Tutu Hanover converted off a two-hole trip to win for driver Tim Tetrick and trainer Jim King Jr. in a stakes, track and Canadian record time.

"She's done things we didn't think could be done," said King Jr. post-race. "About the time she walked in my barn I could



Sentinel. The fillies didn't disappoint, sitting one-two from start to finish.

Alicorn and driver Louis Philippe Roy blasted from post-five and hung up an opening-quarter of :26.4, while Lyons Sentinel followed in second. Reflect With Me got away third and hugged the rail for most of the mile.

After a second-quarter breather of :28.4, Alicorn faced pressure from Somebeachsometime, who had been parked every step of the mile after starting from post-nine. Peaky Sneaky failed to stay with the first-up challenger while in a second-over position, which left room for Tetrick to slide off the rail at three-quarters with Lyons Sentinel.

Alicorn went into sprint mode after reaching

three-quarters in 1:23.1, but Lyons Sentinel was too much to handle. The King Jr. trainee stormed by powerfully in :26 to win by half a length. Alicorn finished second, while Reflect With Me couldn't find room up the rail in the stretch and settled for third over JK First Lady.


"I just didn't want to give Roy too much space," said Tetrick.

"I didn't want to give him three or four lengths and get the half cheap and take off from me, so I put her on the back and I took a chance of getting locked in, but it all worked out."

A \$55,000 yearling purchase at the Standardbred Horse Sales Company's auction in Harrisburg, PA, Lyons Sentinel has stamped herself as harness racing's top two-year-old pacing filly for owners Threelyonsracing of Brantford, ON. The filly, who was bred by Hanover Shoe Farms, has now won five in a row and is six for nine on the season with \$562,330 earned.

Lyons Sentinel's record mile broke the previous Canadian record of 1:50.1, which she matched in last week's elimination. The now-fastest two-year-old filly in Canadian racing history returned \$3.40 for a \$2 win ticket.

Caviart Ally defended her Milton Stakes title with a stakes record 1:48.3 victory in Saturday's \$250,000 event at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The 5-year-old pacing mare shot to the front for driver Andrew McCarthy and never looked back, pacing a :53.3 back-half to secure her second Milton Stakes victory.

"I knew in the post parade she was going to be good," said McCarthy of Caviart Ally. "She usually tells me and she was very focused and had her mind on the job."

A model of consistency, Caviart Ally started from post-eight in the nine-horse field and went off at odds of 4-1. She



McCarthy stomped on the gas pedal in the third-quarter, posting a :26.3 split. The duo proceeded to say goodnight to their rivals and sprinted home in :27 to win by a length and three-quarters. Kissin In The Sand finished second, while Seaswift Joy N and Apple Bottom Jeans completed the Superfecta. Youaremycandygirl finished eighth.

Owned by Caviart Farms, Caviart Ally joined the barn of trainer Brett Pelling this season after former trainer Noel Daley returned to his home country of Australia.



# Elizabeth Yontz – co-owner Anvil and Lace Farm

Elizabeth Yontz, co-owner of *Anvil and Lace*, an up-and-coming breeding farm located in central Kentucky, hopes her farm will one day be mentioned in the same sentence as the sport's elite breeding operations.

Yontz didn't grow up in a harness racing family, but got her enjoyment riding and showing horses.

"I did everything from team roping, hunter jumpers, and even went to the Nationals showing minis. It wasn't until after college that I started working for Schare Adams (Saga Farms) before being hired as the yearling manager for Mr. Leavitt at Walnut Hall Ltd," said Yontz.

Born and raised in the Bluegrass State of Kentucky, it didn't come as a surprise that she would choose a career working with horses.

"I grew up in a one-stoplight town — about 45 minutes north of Louisville. I re-located to Midway when I started college and stayed in the Lexington area. In 2015, Doug and I bought the farm where *Anvil and Lace* is. Before that, we owned a small place where we kept our riding horses," said Beth

Doug Yontz, Beth's husband and partner, is also a farrier, which certainly comes in handy when you own and operate a horse farm.

"Doug and his partner do all the shoeing, but he also helps me with chores when he can," she said.

Today, *Anvil and Lace* is the home to about 100 horses, which consists of broodmares, foals, yearlings, and several turnouts.

This is a great accomplishment being that they have only been established for four years.

"We are only selling our horses in the Lexington sale this year and feel we have something special for everyone," Beth said.

In fact, the very first foal of Fear The Dragon was born at *Anvil and Lace* on Jan. 25, 2019. It was a gray filly out of the Cambest mare, Calvados Hall.

"The first mare I ever owned was a mare named Dancewiththebest, who is the dam of Dancin' Yankee — a \$1.9 million winner. I guess you could say she will always be my favorite.

"As far as getting attached — everything I have is for sale. This is a business and I have to run it as such, so I try hard not to get attached. We are not a big name farm, so I really don't get many calls to sell privately, but as long as they haven't been entered in a sale, he or she can be sold. This year we will sell about 30 horses — that's double of what I consigned last year. The farm is growing and we are getting some very good clients. This is a fun ride we are on," Beth said, laughing.

Of course it's not all fun and games, for there's a lot of work in prepping babies for a sale.

"At Anvil and Lace we start bringing the babies in earlier than most farms, mainly to keep the horses from getting too bleached out in the sun. We teach them to tie groom 5-6 days a week. They all get a weekly bath and a lot of elbow grease goes into it. I treat my business like a school and after my horses sell I feel like my students graduated with honors. It's very fulfilling. I love what I'm doing and give it 100 per cent. I feel blessed to be able to do what I love and hope all the hard work pays off. Like many other people, I would love to breed a Little Brown Jug winner," said Beth.



# **Lindy The Great sets track record winning Caesars Trotting Classic**

Lindy The Great burst from the pack at the top of the stretch and trotted to a three and three-quarter length victory Friday (Sept. 20) to capture the \$230,000 Caesars Trotting Classic for free-for-all trotters at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino. The 5-year-old Crazed—Highscore Kemp stallion stopped the timer in 1:51.1 to equal the fastest mile ever trotted over the Anderson, IN oval. The Caesars Trotting Classic headlined a Grand Circuit card that offered purses in excess of \$1.4 million and some of the sport's top stars.

"I liked him more today than the last two times I drove him. I felt like the last two times he was too aggressive and I couldn't get him to relax through the mile," said driver Louis Philippe Roy. "He was perfect today. He still made the lead,

but I didn't rush him because I didn't want him too excited. After that, he was a gentleman; I could drive him with two fingers."

Sent off at odds of 5-1, Roy and Lindy The Great moved to the lead from post five and soon found themselves in the pocket once Crystal Fashion and David Miller pushed to the front on the way to a :55 opening half. Marion Marauder, last year's Caesars Trotting Classic champion, grabbed the cover and advanced to second as the field entered the turn. However, turning for home, Roy and his Domenico Cecere-trained trotter were up for the challenge, quickly separating themselves from the field by open lengths to score their sixth win of the season and fifth consecutive. Mission Accepted and Chris Page finished second followed by favorite Guardian Angel As and Tim Tetrick.

Owned by K R Breeding LLC, breeder of the stallion, and Robert Rudolph, Lindy The Great raised his seasonal bankroll

to \$168,965. His career earnings stand at \$571,775. He returned \$13.20-\$9.20-\$5.40 with the victory. The winning time eclipsed the 1:51.3 mark established by Southwind Chrome last week at Hoosier Park, and matched the time registered by gelding Bridge To Jesse's in August. Lindy The Great now heads to Lexington for the Allerage.

It was a tough night for favorites in Hoosier Park's highest profile events Friday. Yannick Gingras called an audible with **This Is The Plan** in the \$176,000 Harrah's Hoosier Park Pacing Derby for free-for-all pacers, and the change in tactics produced a 1:48.4 victory for the Ron Burke trainee. Endeavor and Sam Widger raced a tough second while Filibuster Hanover settled for third after cutting the mile. Favorite McWicked raced sixth.

"Sometimes you get a scenario in your head. I didn't tell anybody, but decided to race him from behind," Gingras said. "I figured if I take him back and follow McWicked, we'll take our shots from there."

Lining up from post two, This Is The Plan settled for fifth early as Filibuster Hanover and Endeavor fired for the lead with the latter clicking off a :26.3 opening quarter. Chris Page moved Filibuster Hanover to the front and with McWicked first up in fourth, Gingras slipped in behind the favorite. This Is The Plan was in perfect position turning for home, dashing to the wire with a :26.2 last panel to finish a quarter length in front.

"He's been so good since the Ben Franklin," Gingras said. "He's never put in a bad performance. Like last week, he finished seventh, but he raced as hard as any horse."

The Somebeachsomewhere—That's The Plan 4-year-old picked up his third win in 16 starts this season. Bred by Moni Market Breeders, the gelding is owned by Burke Racing Stable LLC, Weaver Bruscemi LLC, J&T Silva- Purnel & Libby and Lawrence Karr. The triumph pushed the pacer's seasonal earnings to \$743,598. He returned \$9.60-\$4.80-\$4.20 to his backers.

Indiana sensation **Priceless** collected her biggest payday of the season with a 1:51.1 victory in the \$230,000 Kentuckiana Stallion Management stake for freshman pacing fillies. Driven by trainer Brandon Bates, the Rockin Image lass used a pocket trip to perfection, pacing home to a two-length margin at the wire in a lifetime best performance.

"It worked out exactly the way I had hoped. When Tim left (with favorite Beyond Ecstasy) I was ecstatic," Bates said. "He cut some nice fractions in the race and it was pretty easy from there."

The victory was the fifth in seven starts for the filly, bred by Mark Graber, Mervin Graber and Jacob Graber. Kevin Miller and Bert Hochsprung own the freshman, whom Hochsprung said could be headed to the Breeders Crown at the conclusion of the Indiana Sires Stakes campaign.

"I don't know if we can beat them, but I'm probably going to give her a shot," he said. "I told myself tonight that if we could beat this group, we're probably going."

Favorite **Sherry Lyns Lady** and Tim Tetrick battled back to nose out Rock Swan, driven by his brother, Trace, to take the \$215,000 Kentuckiana Stallion Management stake for freshman filly trotters in a time of 1:54.2. Crucial rounded out the trifecta. Trained by Jim Campbell for Coyote Wynd Farms, the victory was the second in nine outings for the Father Patrick 2-year-old.

"I saw him coming," Tetrick said of his brother and Rock Swan. "He had a jump on me and I was just hoping I could catch him late, and I did. Mine was a little funny in the last turn and she cost me a couple of steps, but good horses overcome that and she got up there and got it done."

Bred by Steve Stewart and Timot Stable Inc., Sherry Lyns Lady now possesses seasonal earnings of \$264,154.

**Century Farroh** showed why he was favored in the \$170,000 Jennas Beach Boy for sophomore colt and gelding pacers. One of four supplemental entries into the race, the son of Mach Three claimed his 12th win in 14 seasonal starts, winning in 1:49.1. Crimson And Chrome raced second while Rockie Got Framed finished third.

Starting from the second tier, Sylvain Filion placed the colt on the front racing to a :54.3 first half. Once on the engine, he dictated the pace before going on to a one-length score. Dr. Ian Moore, who trains the colt for Ratchford Stable NS, said that the lightly-staked horse could return to Hoosier Park this fall, and a supplement into the Breeders Crown is not out of the question, saying he deserves a shot on his home turf.

"I'll talk to the owner tonight and we'll see what he says. Basically, right now, this time of year with any horse it's sort of week to week because he's been going since the end of January, it's been a long grind," said Moore. "Every decision we make from here on in will be week to week."

**Sawyer's Desire** and Gingras used a :26.4 last quarter to get by favored Odds On Osiris to capture the \$125,000 Elevation for freshman colt and gelding pacers in a lifetime best 1:51. Trained by Ron Burke for Burke Racing Stable LLC, Weaver Bruscemi LLC and breeder David Wills, the victory was the second of the season for the Real Desire gelding. Sent off at 8-1 odds, he paid \$18.60-\$4.00-\$3.20.

Favored Evident Beauty, driven by David Miller, kept a neck in front of Grand Swan and Lewayne Miller in deep stretch to score a 1:53.3 triumph in the \$135,000 Moni Maker for sophomore trotting fillies. The Trixton 3-year-old, bred by White Birch Farm, collected her seventh win in 12 starts, improving her seasonal earnings to \$487,206. Her career tally now stands at \$735,398 for trainer Nifty Norman and owners Melvin Hartman, Little E LLC and R A W Equine Inc.



# Hennessey is wrapping up record season at Tioga Downs

It is no surprise to find Wally Hennessey winning a high rate of races in upstate New York during the summer. The Hall of Fame driver, who spends the non-summer months at Florida's Pompano Park, has enjoyed countless years of success at Saratoga's harness racing track going back to the late 1980s.

This year, though, Hennessey has spent the summer competing at Tioga Downs. He decided the change would benefit the handful of trotters in his stable, the majority of which he thought would perform better on Tioga's five-eighths-mile oval compared to Saratoga's half-mile circuit.

As it turned out, Hennessey's horses did not thrive at Tioga, but Hennessey did.

With two nights of racing remaining in the 58-day Tioga Downs meet, Hennessey sits comfortably atop the driver standings with 131 wins. The total is a record for the track, which opened in 2006, shattering the previous high of 91 shared by Jim Marohn Jr. (2014) and Howard Parker (2007). Hennessey's win rate at Tioga is nearly 28 per cent.

"My main reason for going wasn't that I was thinking I was going to be the leading driver," Hennessey said. "My reason was because of my stable. As it turned out, I didn't do as well as I expected to do with my own stable and I did way better than I expected to do driving. So, you never know."

Over the past 10 years, Hennessey won nearly 900 races during his summer sojourns in Saratoga, so it was not an easy decision to change his routine.

"I love Saratoga, I love the town, I love the people there," said Hennessey, who turns 63 on Oct. 4. "I've seen kids raised and families and I've known people a long time. But this is a business, and this was a business decision. It wasn't something I was doing with my heart. I was doing it with my head.

"When you're making a change, especially at my age, the older you get, the harder it is to do. There is always that unknown. But it couldn't have worked any better. I met so many nice people, and I think in life that's quite a thing too,

that you're able to meet new people.

"The people were so friendly and respectful. That's kind of the way I was raised on Prince Edward Island. They remind me of the same type people. I enjoyed it. I don't know where I'm going next year, but if that's my choice, I wouldn't be second-guessing it."

Hennessey, whose decision to race at Tioga was made easier knowing that a number of horsemen from Pompano spent the summer there, graded his experience an "A-plus." He will drive the final two nights at Tioga Downs and then return to Florida and get ready for the Pompano Park meet, which begins Nov. 3. He will use October to get his stable ready for action after turning out his trotters three weeks ago.

"My horses were just fair," said Hennessey, who has won the past four driving titles at Pompano. "Good isn't good enough for me, I have high expectations. My horses didn't race that great. I'm not sugar-coating nothing. They were not near as good as I thought they should be. I shut them down to refresh them for Pompano.

"I won't be doing any driving (until Pompano resumes), and I need that as well, mentally and physically," he said. "But I'm very happy."

# **Zacon Gio brings win streak to Yonkers International Trot**

In 1993, Holger Ehlert was working as an assistant trainer in Wim Paal's stable. Paal sent Embassy Lobell to New York to represent France in the International Trot that year and Mike Lachance kept the American-bred well off a blistering early pace.

However, as the field came into the stretch for the second of three times, Lachance misjudged the 1 1/4-mile stakes distance. He yanked on the left line and urged Embassy Lobell up the pylons, passing Norway's Prince Of Mischief and Germany's Sea Cove to take third passing the wire with one circuit remaining. Although Embassy Lobell continued to track in third for the final half-mile, he lost ground in the stretch as Giant Force out-dueled Meadow Prophet to win the \$500,000 stakes.

Ehlert's next chance to experience International Trot glory didn't come for another 23 years. After 10 years with Paal, Ehlert went out on his own in 1994, moved to Italy, where he met his wife, Anne, and started a family. In 2013, Ringostarr Treb came to Ehlert's barn and after the trotter posted a strong season in Italy in 2016, he earned an invitation to the \$1 million Yonkers International Trot.

The International Trot dream would slip through Ehlert's fingers again, though. Shortly before Ringostarr Treb was scheduled to fly to New York, a failed blood test prevented the horse from traveling to the United States.

"That was really big disappointment for us," Anne Ehlert said via email. "The horse was top at the time, and we didn't understand why the tests were not okay. Later on, the veterinarian explained what the problem was. He maybe had had a tick bite earlier and that made his antibodies high. It is forbidden to travel to the U.S. if that value is over a certain level. We got his test result in the same day as the flight, so there was nothing we could do, and we couldn't have known it earlier. That was tough for the whole team."

Although Holger Ehlert's two brushes with the International Trot proved memorable for the wrong reasons, he and Anne hope to make good memories in this year's renewal of the Yonkers International. The pair will bring Zacon Gio across the Atlantic to compete in the \$1 million stake.

"It would mean a lot. It has always been our biggest dream to win this race," Anne Ehlert said. "This time we really wish that everything goes right. We believe it is a third time charmed and we will be very proud to present the Italian

flag."

Ehlert has 120 horses in training at his Pisa, Tuscany stable and Anne works in breeding and breaking babies, in addition to taking care of some of the older horses. Zacon Gio's personality helps him stand out from the pack.

"Zacon Gio is like yearling and always willing to play, never serious. He is not big, medium size American-type horse. He looks like he is out of Yankee Glide, the sire of his dam," Anne Ehlert said. "He is funny to work with, but you have to be always alert. He sees and hears things that nobody else sees. The previous trainer said that he was always like that."

A 4-year-old by Ruty Grif out of the Yankee Glide mare May Glade Font Sm, Zacon Gio began his career with trainer Domenico Minopoli. Zacon Gio won 9 of his first 16 races, but failed to make an impression in stakes, finishing eighth in the Group 1, 154,000€ Gran Premio Citta' Di Napoli in June 2018. By August, Zacon Gio was transferred to Ehlert.

"The owners always believed that he was important and wanted to try something new for him. They called Holger and

sent him to us," Anne Ehlert said.

After finishing fourth in his debut for the stable at Cesena on Sept. 1, 2018, Zacon Gio hasn't been beaten. His win streak began next out in Bologne Oct. 25 and after four more wins in as many tries through Feb. 23, 2019, Zacon Gio earned another try in stakes company and faced his toughest test.

Zacon Gio drew post 12 in the Group 2 Premio Citta' Di Torino at Turin on April 7. The seven-across configuration meant Zacon Gio would start in the second tier behind the five horse in a 14-horse field.

Despite racing uncovered on the rim for much of the 2,060-meter stakes, when driver Roberto Vecchione kicked out the plugs and put the whip on Zacon Gio's tail approaching the final turn, Zacon Gio assumed the lead and quickly kicked away from the field. Vecchione rested the whip back on his shoulder in the stretch as Zacon Gio cruised to a 2 1/2-length victory. After witnessing the romp, the Ehlerts knew they had a special horse.

Zacon Gio connected again in the Group 2 Gran Premio Regione Campania on April 30 before meeting French star Face Time Bourbon in the Group 1 Premio Unione Europea on May 19. Vecchione sent Zacon Gio off the wings of the gate and the Italian trotter led throughout the 2,080-meter contest while the Face Time Bourbon raced first-over and applied pressure.

Zacon Gio turned away Face Time Bourbon at the midway point of the far turn and entered the stretch with a clear lead. Although he looked vanquished on the turn, the French champion took another shot at the Italian in the stretch, cutting into Zacon Gio's advantage with each stride. With Vecchione cracking the lines, imploring with the whip, and bouncing in the bike, Zacon Gio held off Face Time Bourbon by a half-length to score in the 407,000€ stakes.

"We would have been happy even if Zacon Gio arrived second behind Face Time Bourbon," Ehlert said. "It was great to win that race and it was really emotional. Face Time Bourbon is one of the favorites for Prix d'Amérique 2020."

Zacon Gio earned another Group 1 win in the 154,000€ Gran Premio Tino Triossi on June 29. Two more wins Aug. 25 and Sept. 14, when he took the Premio Citta' Di Follonica in an 11-length romp, extend his win streak to 11 entering the

Yonkers International Trot. Overall, Zacon Gio is 20-for-30 with \$412,510 earned.

"Amazing has been the way to describe how he won all those races. It does not add extra pressure, but of course it would be great if that winning streak will continue," Ehlert said.

Despite his impressive resume, Zacon Gio has never raced outside Italy. The move was by design, but now, the Ehlerts and owner Giuseppe Franco are ready to venture away from home with their star trotter.

"He was not ready earlier," Ehlert said. "For us (it was not a difficult decision) at all. We had (the International) in mind already after Turin. The owner had to think about it for 5 minutes, but this is a once in the lifetime possibility, so they said, 'let's go."

Ehlert believes dealing with the quarantine regulations will be the most difficult aspect of the journey. The European contingent for the International will be stabled at Yonkers for the week leading up to the International Oct. 12 and will spend most of the time in their stalls, with exceptions made for training on the Hilltop oval and grazing in the track's infield.

"The biggest challenge is absolutely quarantine," Ehlert said. "Zacon Gio is used to going to the paddock every day and he won't have that possibility. He's never flown, but he travels well, so we believe the flight is not going to be problem for him."

Zacon Gio's nine rivals in the Yonkers International Trot include defending champion Cruzado Dela Noche (Sweden) and 2018 Hambletonian winner Atlanta (U.S.). Guardian Angel AS will also represent the U.S. and Marion Marauder will race for Canada. The other European invaders are Bahia Quesnot (France), Lionel (Norway), Norton Commander (Germany), Slide So Easy (Denmark), and Uza Josselyn.

"We are very excited. We are not afraid of anybody, but we have respect for everybody," Ehlert said.

The \$1 million Yonkers International Trot is slated for Saturday, Oct. 12 at Yonkers Raceway. The card will also feature a pair of \$250,000 invitationals, the 1 1/4-mile Harry Harvey Trot and 1-mile Dan Rooney Pace.





# Play For Pay, Fully A Virgin win ISS divisions at Hoosier

Fresh off a big night of Grand Circuit racing action, two divisions of Indiana Sires Stakes for 3-year-old pacing fillies were the featured attraction at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino on Saturday (Sept. 21). The sophomore pacing fillies have now completed seven rounds of their eight round series. The Indiana Sires Stakes season will culminate with the \$250,000 Super Finals for each division on Oct. 11.

In the opening division, **Play For Pay** and driver Brandon Bates switched up their tactics and opted for a trip off the pace and came charging late in the lane to score in 1:51.1. Dojea Rita and Charlie Conrad were the first to get a call through the opening panel in :27.1 before yielding the lead to Lady Capulet and Michael Oosting just before the half.

Lady Capulet clicked off fractions of :55.2 and 1:23.2 and when the field turned for home, it was a cavalry charge to the wire. Using the long Hoosier Park stretch to her advantage, Play For Pay tipped off tiring cover and used a :26.3 closing kick to get the win by a head. Pure Maid and LeWayne Miller finished second while This Peach Rocks and Ross Leonard rounded out the trifecta. Sent off at odds of 5-1, Play For Pay returned \$13.60 at the betting windows.

Trained by Michael Arnold, Play For Pay recorded her fourth win from 15 starts this season. The daughter of Tellitlikeitis—Fox Valley Ivy now sports a lifetime bankroll of \$162,335 and is owned by Ira Steinberg.

Fully A Virgin and Michael Oosting used similar tactics to get up in the final strides of the mile and capture the second division of the stakes action in 1:50.1. Utilizing a :25.4 closing quarter, Fully A Virgin tipped off cover and powered home a winner to stick a nose in front of stablemate Pansy's Image and Trace Tetrick. Rockin Nola and Joey Putnam also rallied well late to finish third. The 1:50.1 clocking was a new lifetime best for the Shane Bowermaster trainee and the third win from her last four outs.

With the win, the homebred daughter of Always A

Virgin—Full Of Gold recorded her sixth win from 14 starts this season. Owned and bred by Emerald Highlands Farm, Fully A Virgin has now amassed \$205,180 in lifetime purse earnings.

# Goes Down Smooth sets track, stakes record in Keystone

Goes Down Smooth drew away from the field late with a powerful finishing kick that carried him to victory in a track-record 1:52.3 in Saturday's \$75,299 Keystone Classic for 3-year-old colt and gelding trotters at The Meadows. The mile lowered the mark set by **Explosivebreakaway** in another Keystone Classic division only about 30 minutes earlier.

The event was contested over three divisions, with **Lindy's Crazy Hall** taking the other split.

Goes Down Smooth battled three wide for the early lead, but after Matt Kakaley gave him a 29 second-quarter breather, the Muscle Hill—Peach Martini gelding made a shambles of the race, defeating Nextroundsonme by a widening 9-1/2 lengths. Darty finished third.

"I let him trot out a little bit, but he did it real easy today," Kakaley said. "He's been good for quite a while now."

Ron Burke trains the winner, who vaulted over \$200,000 in career earnings, for Burke Racing Stable, William Switala, James Martin and Weaver Bruscemi LLC. The time also is a stake record and the fastest this year by a sophomore gelding trotter on a five-eighths-mile track.

While Explosivebreakaway's 1:52.4 performance will go down as one of the most fleeting track records in The Meadows history, he had plenty to celebrate. He found the pocket for Tom Jackson in a blistering :26 opening panel. The Explosive Matter-Phaeton gelding brushed outside through the lane and downed Kate's Massive by 3-1/4 lengths, with Stonebridge Symba third.

"I wasn't worried about my horse finishing; I was worried about the horse in front of me carrying me far enough," Jackson said. "He took me plenty far enough. We changed his shoes after his last race here, and he's been a different horse ever since."

Fred Grant trains Explosivebreakaway, who lifted his lifetime bankroll to \$131,925, and owns with Janice Rubin, Steven Katz and Murray Brown.

# \$75,300 Keystone Classic — 3-Year-Old Colt and Gelding Pacers

**Pyro** and **Highlandbeachlover** captured the divisions in Saturday's other Keystone Classic.

Kakaley hustled Pyro to the point from the rail and eschewed the opportunity to release a pair of early challengers and take a covered trip.

"I wanted to line them up and have my colt in front, give him a shot on the lead," he said. "I thought he was the best. He dug in, and he was good."

Kakaley knew his horse, as Pyro prevailed in 1:50.3, 1/2 length better than Waterway. Lyons Night Hawk completed the ticket.

Pyro, a Sweet Lou—Whetstone Hanover gelding, now boasts \$170,266 in earnings for Burke and owners Burke Racing Stable, Larry Karr, Phillip Collura and Weaver Bruscemi LLC.

Highlandbeachlover scored impressively in 1:51.1 after a desultory first quarter that frustrated Aaron Merriman, who couldn't put the Somebeachsomewhere-Rockn Highland gelding where he wanted to.

"This horse isn't the easiest horse to drive, so I really didn't have a plan, to be honest with you," Merriman said. "This horse has some go, but there's nothing real easy about him. He was very resilient today. He's usually not a front-end horse, but I thought I better put him in the best stop to win,"

Aflame Hanover was second, beaten 1-1/4 lengths, with He's Packin third. The judges reviewed the actions of three horses, including the winner, before declaring the race official with the order of finish unchanged. Desyllas Racing, Elmore's Races Horses and William Beck campaign Highlandbeachlover. Winning trainer Kelly O'Donnell indicated the horse is eligible for stakes at the Red Mile but that his schedule has not been determined.

Live racing at The Meadows resumes Monday when the program features a pair of Keystone Classics for 3-year-old fillies — a \$65,500 trot and a \$59,300 pace. First post is 1:05 p.m.

# Massachusetts standardbreds to get increased percentage

It has been announced that after a meeting between the Horse Racing Committee (HRC) and the Massachusetts Gaming Commission (MGC) on Wednesday afternoon (Sept. 18) to discuss the distribution percentage, the HRC voted to recommend that the MGC increase the amount allocated to the standardbreds from the Race Horse Development Fund (RHDF) from 60 to 65 per cent.

Rationale for the increase included the strong and rapidly increasing number of standardbreds being bred in the state, the growing popularity of its sire stake program, the increase in the size of the fields in overnight races and the overall number of race dates currently being run at Plainridge Park, which is Massachusetts only operating race track.

It was also noted that the split will not become effective immediately. The recommendation will have to be verified by the Massachusetts legislature and then approved by the MGC.

The HRC said it plans to reconvene during the first quarter of 2020 when the distribution percentage will once again be reviewed.

# Swandre The Giant rebounds at Hoosier Park

Sophomore trotting colts and geldings took another turn in Indiana Sires Stakes action on Thursday (Sept. 19) at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino. The evening's card was highlighted by two \$47,000 divisions in leg seven of eight for the division as the horses prepare for the upcoming Stakes Super Finals next month. Favorites prevailed in both divisions with victories from Martini Show and Swandre The Giant.

After a scratch of the morning line choice, It's A Herbie, in the first division, the race appeared to be wide open. The new pick of the betting public, Martini Show, happily claimed the role of favorite and delivered with Sam Widger guiding the colt to the winner's circle. The winning time of 1:53:4 was a new lifetime mark for the Jeff Cullipher trainee as he also recorded back to back stakes victories.

When the gate opened, Wow Lester with Trace Tetrick grabbed the lead while Martini Show waited patiently in third. The field remained in straight formation as Wow Lester clicked off fractions of :27:2,:56:1 and 1:24:4. Once the horses turned for home, Widger had Martini Show on the attack first-over. Martini Show ranged up to match strides with the leader before digging in late in the lane to get the win by a head. He was followed by Smooth Acceleration with Ricky Macomber Jr. and Gotwuteverittakes with LeWayne Miller. Martini Show returned \$3.00 at the betting windows.

"He had to work for it a bit tonight," driver Sam Widger said. "He's only going to go as hard as you tell him but he takes care of himself. He's a nice colt to drive."

With tonight's victory, Martini Show has now won six of 25 lifetime starts and sports a lifetime bankroll of \$184,640 for owners Pollack Racing and Jeffrey Cullipher. The son of Swan For All-Bar Maid was bred by Steven Mast.

After racing in the 2019 Little Brown Jug earlier in the evening, Hall of Famer David Miller arrived to Harrah's Hoosier Park just in time to steer Swandre The Giant to a victory in the second division of the stakes action. After making a costly break at Woodbine last week, Swandre The Giant rebounded with a decisive gate-to-wire effort to score in 1:53.

Swan On A Mission and John De Long took the early lead while Swandre The Giant grabbed a pocket seat. Once the field hit the opening quarter in :27, Swandre The Giant wanted his turn on the front and led the field through middle splits of :56.1 and 1:23. Turning for home, the only challenger was Dg's Caviar with Andy Shetler, but ultimately Swandre The Giant prevailed with Dg's Caviar settling for second while Sign Here N Here with Brandon Bates in third. Swandre the Giant paid \$2.40 to win.

"After last week's break, they put his regular shoes back on him," Miller said. "He was really comfortable tonight, and raced really nice and easy. He's definitely back on track."

Swandre The Giant, the son of Swan For All—Adagio, has now won six of 13 lifetime starts. He boasts a lifetime bankroll of \$496,993 for owners Diamond Creek Racing, J&T Silva Stables and Howard Taylor. The Ron Burke trainee was bred by DM Stables.
