Stag Party is a stud in Metro Pace

David Miller won his first Metro Pace by driving Stag Party to a dominant 1:50.4 victory in Saturday's \$890,000 race at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Stag Party and driver David Miller put on a show to win the \$890,000 Metro Pace on Saturday night at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The Casie Coleman-trained 2-year-old pacing colt came first-up on the final turn from fourth and proceeded to turn the Metro final into a laughter by drawing away with ease in the lane for a 4 ¼ lengths victory in 1:50.4.

"My horse was full of pace the whole way and around the last turn I had a pretty good feeling that he was going to go all the way," said Miller, who had never won the Metro before

ready to tell them we're shutting him down for the season and bringing him back as a 3-year-old."

A \$125,000 Harrisburg yearling purchase, Stag Party, bred by Fred Hertrich III of Seaford, DE, has now earned \$642,489 for owners John Fielding, Mac Nichol, McKinlay & Fielding and West Wins Stable.

"We've had a lot of luck in this business and we've had a ton of fun and this one is really special because my thoroughbred partner Fred Hertrich actually bred the horse so it makes it extra special," said John Fielding after capturing his first Metro. "I've had horses with Casie for a couple years now and been absolutely thrilled with the job she does. Her and her team have done an amazing job and this colt is really special."

Coleman is currently undecided on when Stag Party's next start will be but did note the Metro winner will be pointed towards the Ontario Sires Stakes Super Final and Breeders Crown.

Stag Party paid \$5.30 to win.

Tall Drink Hanover powers to Shes A Great Lady victory

Tall Drink Hanover converted off a perfect second-over steer from driver Andrew McCarthy to win the \$590,000 Shes A Great Lady on Saturday night at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The Tony Alagna trained 2-year-old pacing filly got away fifth and was able to pick up cover at half, which led to her powering by rivals in the lane for a career-best 1:51.1 victory.

"I wasn't even too concerned if I had to come third-over, I knew that her kick in the stretch would probably be good enough," said McCarthy. "It worked out great that I got a second-over trip and I couldn't ask for any better."

Longshot Art Lecture blasted from the outside to the top and battled with a parked out Queen Of The Pride to a :27 opening-quarter. The outside challenger cleared to the top entering the backstretch and reached the half in a sensible :55.4.

Sylph Hanover committed first-up from fourth going into the final turn, which allowed Tall Drink Hanover to get towed towards the lead. Queen Of The Pride maintained a lead of just over a length at three-quarters in 1:23.3.

Queen Of The Pride crossed the line fourth, while elimination winner Ideation Hanover was fifth.

A daughter of Captaintreacherous—Take Into Account bred by Hanover Shoe Farms, Tall Drink Hanover swept the elimination and final of the Shes A Great Lady to improve her record to five wins in eight starts. The \$35,000 Harrisburg yearling purchase has now earned \$406,392 for

"One of the rare occasions when normally it's \$350,000 not \$35,000 for us," said Katz of purchasing Tall Drink Hanover as a yearling. "There she was in the ring and nothing was going on for whatever reason. She was four or five from the end of the day at Harrisburg. We liked her and were able to buy her for \$35,000 and it was a surprise to us."

Tall Drink Hanover's victory gives McCarthy and Alagna their first Shes A Great Lady titles. A \$2 win ticket on the Captaintreacherous filly returned \$4.20.

Caviart Ally delivered another dominating performance to win the \$255,000 Milton Stakes on Saturday night at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The 4-year-old pacing mare and driver Andrew McCarthy made a backstretch move to the lead from fourth and pulled away in the stretch for a three-length victory in 1:51.2.

"I really had to leave hard to get away third and then I worked her pretty hard down the backside get the front," said McCarthy. "I chased her on the last turn a little bit to get the engines revving and she did respond, she perked right up and responded."

Trained by Noel Daley, Caviart Ally entered the Milton final off a stunning career-best 1:48.3 victory in her elimination and made no mistakes Saturday to best a deep field of older pacing mares.

Gural has fingers crossed that \$20 million in aid may be coming from New Jersey

On Monday, there is supposed to be a senate hearing on a bill that could help horse racing in the state. If that aid comes through, some \$6 million could be allocated to purses at the Meadowlands.

Meadowlands Racetrack owner Jeff Gural said he is hoping good news may be coming this week in the form of \$20 million in aid from New Jersey to help the state's beleaguered horse racing industry.

"There's a hearing Monday, a senate hearing on the bill," Gural said, adding he is, "reasonably optimistic" such a measure will pass after speaking to both Governor Phil Murphy and Senate President Stephen Sweeney last week.

"With the help of the SBOA (Standardbred Breeders and Owners Association), Mike Gulotta, Bob Boni, John Campbell... I think we've made a convincing argument that with the horse shortage that we can no longer expect to be able to survive and we would have to make drastic changes in the racing program next year if we don't get this money," Gural said.

"Other states that we compete with are subsidizing their purses. Pennsylvania gets \$250 million for the horse racing industry and New York is about \$200 million... I think it's very obvious that Yonkers, Pocono and Chester, probably 90 per cent of the money in each race comes from slot machines as opposed to wagering on horse racing. Whereas, at the Meadowlands, up until now, 100 per cent of the money that's in the purse account comes from either horse racing or from me."

If the \$20 million is approved, Gural said half would go to thoroughbreds, which have decided to allocate all \$10 million to purses. On the standardbred side, it is estimated about \$6 million would go to purses at the Meadowlands, Freehold would get a cut, the New Jersey Sires Stakes program would receive about \$1.2 million, about \$600,000 would be set aside for bonuses for New Jersey-breds racing at the Meadowlands and there would be money for breeders' awards.

"They want to see the farmland preserved and green grass,"

Gural said of some in the New Jersey government. “They want to see the jobs that are created at these farms. I think 10 years ago there were 3,000 mares bred in New Jersey and I think this year there was fewer than 300.

“Obviously, it’s not over until it’s over – as a famous New Jersey resident once said. But I think, (if the aid comes through) putting an extra \$6 million into the purse account next year will see our purses, especially when the Pennsylvania tracks are open, be higher than they will have in Pennsylvania.

“We’d probably go back to having late closers at the Meadowlands, so I think the \$6 million would dramatically bring the Meadowlands back to what it once was in terms of high quality racing. You would not, hopefully, be watching non-winners of \$2,500 race at the Meadowlands, but who knows? There’s such a horse shortage, it’s a real problem,” Gural said.

As for sports betting which started this year at the Meadowlands, Gural said it’s had mixed results, so far.

Though, unlike past years, the Meadowlands is now open on Sundays when NFL games are on at adjacent Met Life Stadium – “we were able to make a deal with the teams to allow us to be open” – he’s not sure enough people know they can make sports wagers at the facility before going to a game.

“Initially, people told me that thousands of people were going to come before the game to make a bet on the game and that hasn’t happened,” Gural said, adding he needs to work with the stadium leadership to find a better way to get fans between the stadium and the Meadowlands.

Still, the sports betting numbers have been strong.

“Our numbers have been very strong. In August, there was more money wagered at the Meadowlands than all of the other sites combined – all of the eight or nine casinos, plus Monmouth,” Gural said. “The fact is that New York doesn’t have sports betting, which is a big help, other than the fact that I also own a casino in New York, which could use sports betting.”

Encounter with mama Grizzly Bear and cubs as memorable as being inducted into Wall of Fame

When Ron Pierce grew tired of prospecting for gold in Alaska this summer, he decided to liven things up the way only he can – with one heck of a fish tale involving a mama Grizzly Bear and her three cubs.

All things considered, the retired Hall of Fame driver is lucky to have lived to be able to travel to Delaware, OH this week to be inducted into the Little Brown Jug Wall of Fame.

Pierce said he was fishing in Alaska this summer when he hooked a King Salmon that was huge and hard to reel in.

"I was fighting this fish and I looked downstream and there was this Grizzly at 150 yards with three cubs. She was working her way upstream. I'm fighting this fish, fighting this fish and I'm not making any progress. When she got to about 60 yards away with her babies, I thought, 'Well, s---!' I ran up the hill with my pole and braced it in a tree and she and cubs went on upstream.

"When I thought they were far enough away, I went back out and the fish was still on, so I continued fighting the fish and, don't you know, here she comes again. She's coming back and I didn't see her until she was about 40 yards away. And my creel is over there by her, about 10 yards towards her from me, and I wasn't going to go over there because that's too close. I hung my pole in the tree again and climbed back up the hill. When she got to my creel, she tore it up. But, you know what? I'm glad she did that because I sewed it back together and now I can remember that. Every time I pick up my creel, I can see the stitching. She was trying to find something to eat. Then, she went on her way and, when I got back to my pole, the fish was gone."

Pierce said prospecting didn't yield as much gold this summer – "I came home with a couple of ounces of gold." – so he decided to work his way south toward his home in Montana, fishing along the way.

"It was the best move I made," Pierce said. "I was fishing for salmon and steelhead there and I had a ball."

After his grizzly bear encounter – “You don’t mess with the grizzlies, babies or their food.” – Pierce worked his way into British Columbia to a place called Moricetown, near the town of Summit.

“Great area, beautiful area. There’s a river there called Telkwa. The steelhead fishing and the salmon fishing was unreal,” Pierce said.

Occasionally, Pierce will run into some people in the wilderness and his career as a harness driver always is a good conversation starter.

“This one guy, he was mining up in (Alaska). I saw him out there working the mine and I stopped and was bullsh----- with him. His name was Danny Jacobson and, it’s such a small world, he loves the horses, he knew me, and his brother was a lawyer of mine... He was (John) Campbell’s lawyer, too, when we were getting sued over that race bike thing. His brother got us out of that.”

Pierce said the trip to Delaware, OH was fantastic, but came only after he purposely put on a few pounds so people wouldn’t think he was sick.

“I didn’t want anybody to say I was thin, so I over-ate and put on a few extra pounds on purpose to go down there,” he said. “As soon as I pulled into the fairgrounds, I could hear the races going on and Roger on the mic and I was like, ‘Wow: Usually I’m there with a horse. I felt like I really wanted to jump in again.’”

Pierce was officially honored at a dinner on Tuesday night.

“Dave Brower read a proclamation from the County. And another fella had a proclamation from the township and the Town of Delaware,” Pierce said. “Three-quarters of the things they said I did over my career I almost totally forgot about. It reminded me of exactly how much I did accomplish, you know?”

Pierce won the Jug four times – Shady Character (1998), Blissfull Hall (’99), Timesareachanging (’04) and Well Said (’09) – and retired with 9,570 career wins and some \$215 million in earnings. The 62-year-old was enshrined into the Harness Racing Hall of Fame in Goshen, NY in 2005.

On Jug Day, Pierce was handed the reins to a retired Budweiser horse – “It was so cool... , I still had it.” – and was interviewed in the winner’s circle by Jason Settlement.

“The first group of horses I saw go by were the 3-year-old trotting fillies and there were some really pretty fillies. That made me want to drive,” Pierce said. “When the Jug was on the track, I really wanted to get out there.

“That was a great race. There was a little bit of drama and then what a trip (Courtly Choice) went. That was so impressive.”

Pierce said the best part was visiting with old friends.

“I ran into so many friends... I just ran into people

everywhere I went. Good people. It was so good to see so many people that I haven’t seen in a long, long time... I don’t know if they are bullsh----- me or what, but everybody said they miss me so much.

“I didn’t know I was so popular, to tell you the truth. I didn’t know I was missed as much as they said... That made me feel really good, too. I really appreciate everybody’s kindness. It’s good to know that I am missed.”

Pierce is already home in Montana and preparing for another winter in the wilderness.

“I’m going to load up the trailer and come Monday morning, I want to be out of here,” he said. “I’m heading up into the Rocky Mountains and I’m going to try to get a young elk for meat for the winter. They have elk up there. I’m going to bow-hunt for elk.

“When it starts cooling off, I’ll head over the Rockies and drop down into northern California again for the winter. I can salmon fish all winter,” he said.

“It is a beautiful life.”

The sport's top trotters were showcased in the inaugural edition of the \$200,000 Caesars Trotting Classic at Hoosier Park Racing & Casino during an action-packed 14-race card on Friday (Sept. 21) and, as expected, it was a true demonstration of sheer trotting talent. With regular pilot Scott Zeron in the bike, trotting Triple Crown Champion Marion Marauder staged an incredible rally late in the lane and utilized the long Hoosier Park stretch to his advantage to get up in the final strides of the mile in 1:52.4.

Handed the tough, outside post position nine, Marion Marauder was unhurried from the gate and settled along the rail in eighth. Using his customary early gate speed, Sam Widger had I Know My Chip pointed to the front to grab command just before the first quarter in :26.2. Opting out of a pocket trip, Yannick Gingras pointed Hannelore Hanover to the front and she quickly grabbed the lead just before the half to dictate fractions of :56.1 and 1:25.2.

Bridge To Jesse's and John DeLong were unable to find a seat along the rail and began their long first-over journey approaching the final turn. Homicide Hunter and David Miller quickly grabbed the cover and were well placed second-over while Marion Marauder followed suit and were poised to strike from third-over.

Hannelore Hanover was able to put away Bridge To Jesse's and appeared to be up to the task but her biggest threats were still behind her. Homicide Hunter tipped from behind his tiring cover, but it was Marion Marauder who was widest of all with a full head of steam. Utilizing a :26.2 final panel, Marion Marauder dug in gamely in the final strides to hold off a hard charging JL Cruze and Trace Tetrack. Homicide Hunter also rallied well late to round out the trifecta. Sent off as the heavy betting favorite, Marion Marauder returned \$5.60 at the betting windows.

"We never tell Scott how to drive, he knows this horse so well and always takes care of him," trainer Paula Wellwood noted in the winner's circle. "We don't worry about the trip much because he can take a lot of air; he's just a great horse."

The 5-year-old son of Muscle Hill—Spellbound Hanover won for the sixth time this season and for the 20th time in his career. With the win, Marion Marauder sent his lifetime purse earnings over the \$3 million mark for owners Jean Wellwood and Devin Keeling.

Lazarus (Yannick Gingras) rebounded to defeat McWicked on Friday in 1:48.2 in the \$177,000 Hoosier Park Pacing Derby.

Lazarus N fends off McWicked to win Hoosier Park Pacing Derby

It was billed as Round Three of a budding rivalry between two superstar pacers in Lazarus N (Yannick Gingras) and McWicked (David Miller) and the contest lived up to every bit of the hype, as on Friday (Sept. 21) Lazarus N defeated a hard-charging McWicked by a neck in a scintillating edition of the \$177,000 Hoosier Park Pacing Derby at Hoosier Park Racing & Casino in 1:48.4. "He felt very good when I was warming him up so I was confident he would race well tonight," said Jimmy Takter, who conditions Lazarus N for Taylor Made Farm. "We know what a talented horse he is, and he really seems to like it here at Hoosier Park."

Unlike his last race at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Sept. 15 where Gingras drove Lazarus N rather conservatively after his second place finish to McWicked in the \$462,000 Canadian Pacing Derby on Sept. 1, the 6-year-old stallion was placed right on the lead prior to the first turn. Leading the field of nine through a first quarter in :26 and the half-mile in :55, Lazarus N looked very strong on the lead he maintained over Filibuster Hanover and Split The House.

As Lazarus N hit the three-quarter pole in 1:23, McWicked was pacing comfortably in fifth place and when Western Fame moved first-over, he received a perfect second-over trip to commence his bid for victory.

Around the final turn, the separation Lazarus N had placed between himself and the rest of the field began to vanish while

McWicked swung to the outside to close with his customary power.

As the wire loomed ever closer, McWicked was gaining on Lazarus N with every stride, but Lazarus N was determined and held off McWicked by a diminishing neck. Donttellmeagain (Tim Tetrick) used a :24.3 final quarter to finish third.

"He felt just like he did the first time we came to Hoosier Park," Gingras said. "He is definitely back to himself."

Sent to the gate as the even-money favorite, Lazarus N, a son of Bettor's Delight, rewarded his backers with a payout of \$4.40. McWicked, who is trained by Casie Coleman and owned by Ed James, was the public's second selection at odds of 2-1, provided his supporters with \$3.40. Donttellmeagain, (10-1) paid \$4 for his third place finish.

New York Night of Champions in three acts

What did we learn Saturday (Sept. 22) during Yonkers Raceway's hosting of the Empire State's richest night of racing, the 29th New York Night of Champions?

The \$1.8 million event—eight, \$225,000 sire stakes finals for freshmen and sophomores of both sexes and gaits—produced the expected, the unexpected and the 'it's a good thing no one was hurt.'

ACT I—The Expected

Odds-on numbers **Winndevie** (Trond Smedshammer, \$2.30), **Gimpanzee** (Brian Sears, \$2.30), **Plunge Blue Chip** (Ake Svanstedt, \$2.20), **Wisdom Tree** (Tim Tetrick, \$2.50) and **Helpisontheway** (Jim Morrill Jr., \$3.50) delivered their short pari-mutuel promises.

Winndevie grinded by leader Quincy Blue Chip (Morrill Jr.), winning the *Crawford Farms 2-Year-Old Filly Trot* in 1:59. The latter led through intervals of :28.2, :59 and 1:27.4, but couldn't stall the first-over (from post position No. 2) foe, who prevailed by three-quarters of a length. Sensibility (Jordan Stratton) was third, with Amal Hall (Andy Miller) fourth.

The daughter of Credit Winner—Vida De Vie, trained by her driver for owner Purple Haze Stables, is now 6-for-7 this season (3-for-3 here), with earnings of \$227,858. The exacta paid \$8.50, the triple returned \$42.40 and the superfecta paid \$108.50.

Despite the win, Winndevie's 'date' did not seem impressed.

"She wasn't at her best," Smedshammer said. "She's much better in the turns than she was tonight. Very bumpy. She won because no one else was there with her."

Smedshammer said Winndevie was eligible to the Breeders Crown, but "the way she was tonight, she's better off out in the field."

Gimpanzee made it 7-for-7, winning the Agriculture and NYS Horse Breeding Development Fund 2-Year-Old Colt/Gelding Trot in 1:56.3, a track record for his weight class.

From post No. 5, he was third at the :28.2 quarter-mile, then made the lead before a :58.2 intermission. He then finished it off, getting a 1:27.1 three-quarters before that new track standard. Gimpanzee defeated Thunder (Jason Bartlett) by a half-length, his narrowest margin of victory this season. Our White Knight (Miller) was third—some dozen lengths behind—with Horns for Three (Jim Maroon Jr.) fourth.

Gimpanzee, a son of Chapter Seven—Steamy Windows, saw the bankroll improve to \$278,858 for co-owners Courant Inc. and S R F Stable. The exacta (two wagering choices) paid \$3.40, the triple returned \$11.40 and the superfecta paid

\$94.

"Very professional, very mature," Sears said, "He knows what he has to do and goes out there and does it."

"I knew all along he'd be a good one, from when he was training down," trainer Marcus Melander said. "Just a good horse to be around."

All-age track record-holder Plunge Blue Chip had nary more than a qualifier for money in the *Allerage Farm 3-Year-Old Filly Trot*. From post No. 2—and one Svanstedt's five entrants in the race—she strolled early and lost 'em late (:29.2, :58.1, 1:26.3, 1:55.3).

Plunge Blue Chip avenged last season's poor sire stakes finale effort, rolling home by seven lengths. Lima Novelty (Morrill Jr.) was the best of the rest, with Ciao Dolce (Miller) and Fury Road (Dan Dube) rounding out the gimmick finishers.

Plunge Blue Chip, a Muscle Mass—Dunk The Donato lass, has six wins, three seconds and thirds in 11 '18 tries (\$485,101). She is co-owned by her driver/trainer Blue Chip Bloodstock, Little E LLC, Tomas Andersson and Rick Zeron Stables.

Wisdom Tree was the best in her division coming in and coming out, easily winning the *Cameo Hills Farm 3-Year-Old Filly Pace*. From post No. 4, she worked around Newsday (Stratton), then had few issues (:27.4, :57.1, 1:25.2, 1:53.2).

Wisdom Tree defeated Newsday by a length-and-a-half, with a first-up Alexis Faith (Morrill Jr.) third and Checkered Past (Bartlett) fourth.

It was the 11th win in 14 seasonal starts (\$387,351) for Wisdom Tree, a daughter of Betterthancheddar—Wisdom co-owned by Thomas Pollack & Jeff Cullipher and trained by Ed Hart. The exacta paid \$9.10, the triple returned \$22.40 and the superfecta paid \$63.50.

"I'm glad it's over," Hart said. "She's been racing on the front every start, probably because she's the best in there. We haven't put her in a lot of the open stakes since we wanted to stay in the sires, but she's eligible to one at Indiana (Hoosier), Northfield and the Matron (Dover), so she's not done yet."

As for Helpisontheway, he was certainly helped by Yonkers Trot winner Six Pack being ineligible to the final (not enough prelim starts). So, after finished second to that in the Trot and a statebred event here, Helpisontheway had his way in the *Morrisville College Equine Institute 3-Year-Old Colt/Gelding Trot*.

Away fourth from post No. 4, he watched Winning Shadow (Mike Simons) lead (:28, 57, 1:25.3) before that one was put away by 50-1 Purpose Blue Chip (Dan Daley). Helpisontheway was towed behind that live longshot, widening to win by 2¼ lengths.

An out-the-mile The Veteran (Stratton) was second, with Purpose Blue Chip, who outraced his odds, and Winning Shadow were respectively third and fourth.

Helpisontheway, a Chapter Seven—Porque colt trained by Linda Toscano for co-owners Camelot & Bay's Stable and Little E LLC, has seven wins and four seconds in his 13 '18 tries (\$467,775). The exacta (two wagering choices) paid \$15.40, the triple returned \$188 and the superfecta paid \$568.

"Versatility," Toscano said. "He can leave and sit back the way he raced tonight.

"Last season (1-for-8), he was immature. Some 2-year-olds just don't get it. The ability was there. He just needed to figure it out."

ACT II—The Unexpected

Reigning Deo (Morrill Jr., \$42.20) closed from third-over, winning the *Agriculture and NYS Horse Breeding Development Fund 2-Year-Old Colt/Gelding Pace* in 1:54.4. From post No. 4, he watched as Hickfromfrenchlick (Tetrack) led through intervals of :28, :57.1 and 1:25.1. The Sheppard winner slugged it out with Melodie's Magic (Tyler Buter), who surprisingly did not leave from the pole.

Deepest of all arrived Reigning Deo, who whipped 'Melodie' by a length-and-a-half. Artie's Ideal (Marcus Miller) was a pocket third, with Hickfromfrenchlick fading to fourth.

For fifth choice Reigning Deo, a son of Rock N Roll Heaven—Little Miss K co-owned by (breeder) Deo Volente Farms, (trainer) Brett Pelling and Brian Gordon, it was his third win in seven first-season starts (\$193,712). The exacta paid \$89, the triple returned \$661 and the superfecta paid \$2,355.

"We wanted to go through the (sire stakes) program with him," Pelling said. "I mean, he's always carried himself well. We weren't planning to race him at Batavia (10 nights ago), but he was seventh in points, so we figured we needed to."

They were correct, and rewarded.

Moneyshot Hanover (Buter, \$10) 'won the bob' over So Awesome (Tetrack) in the *Winbak Farm 2-Year-Old Filly Pace*. So Awesome was the first leader before giving up to St. Somewhere (George Brennan), That one laid down the law (:27.4, :56) before making an ugly break down the backside the second time.

So Awesome then inherited the front of the fray, getting three-quarters in 1:24.4. She owned a length lead into the lane, but Moneyshot Hanover was able to tag her at the line. Third went to JK American Beauty (Sears), with Hurrikane

Norakane (Dube) fourth.

For third choice Moneyshot Hanover, a daughter of Art Major—Marinade Hanover co-owned by (trainer) Mark Harder, Rick Phillips and Deena Frost, she now 3-for-8 (\$203,408) this season. The exacta paid \$25.20, the triple returned \$151.50 and the superfecta paid \$750.

"She's two fingers to drive," Buter said. "She was bumpy around the last turn, but she dug in

ACT III—The 'It's a Good Thing No One Was Hurt'

The outset of the night's final statebred event, the *Blue Chip Farms 3-Year-Old Colt/Gelding Pace*, was the sort of stuff one can't unsee.

Pole-sitting 6-5 favorite Springsteen (Sears) was off the gate at the start, then hung a dead right, perhaps the victim of some equipment issue. Equipment or not, he impeded those who did not leave, including Heavenly Sound (Marohn Jr.), Rootin' Tootin' (Mark MacDonald) and Twin B Tuffenuff (Brennan).

Getting the worst of it was Ghost Dance (Morrill Jr.), who ended up locking wheels with Springsteen as both found their way to the back fence. That left three horses in contention, with **Rockapelo** (Bartlett, \$11.40) moving from third down the backside the second time and taking over the lead.

From post No. 4, he won by 4½ lengths in 1:53.1. My Delight (Brent Holland) was second, with Ostro Hanover (Dube) third and Heavenly Sound fourth.

Neither two- nor four-legged creature involved in the incident seemed any worse for wear.

For third choice Rockapelo, a Rock N Roll Heaven—Capelo Rose gelding trained by Toscano for owner Enviro Stables, it was his third win in 13 seasonal starts (\$203,5452) and pushed Bartlett over the \$100 million career earnings plateau. The exacta paid \$82.50, the triple returned \$482 and the superfecta paid \$1,943.

"I didn't see what happened, but I heard yelling and I know when you're the inside and you go right, it's not a good thing," Bartlett said.

The morning of his epic victory in the 73rd Little Brown Jug with Courtly Choice, trainer Blake MacIntosh was sitting in the Jug Barn talking about the horse that got him there.

In November of 2008, MacIntosh paid just \$1,500 at the Standardbred Horse Sale's Company's Harrisburg, PA sale for a McArdle filly out of Drawing Card named Bullet Point.

Over six racing seasons, Bullet Point turned that \$1,500 investment into just shy of \$600,000.

"I think Bullet Point was the first one that got me noticed," MacIntosh said.

"She was just a really good overnight horse. She wasn't a stake horse, but she got me rolling and she changed my life. We weren't really into babies before her... she was the first good horse that we broke and had go."

MacIntosh said he simply was at the right place at the right time.

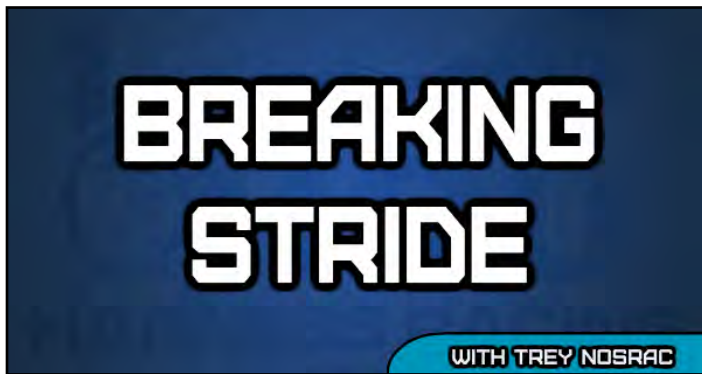
"Anybody could have bought that horse and done the same thing. There's no doubt in my mind that she was just a good horse and I got lucky. You know, it's a lot of luck and hard work," he said. "When I bought her, she was a little smaller and shaggy, but she stood really correct. She was at the end of the sale at Harrisburg and I knew her sister... so I knew the pedigree."

Ten years later, MacIntosh can draw a line from that moment to the Little Brown Jug.

"She was just an iron tough mare and perfect for us. She's for sure one of the main reasons we're here today," he said.

"Where are you going with this? What does it have to do with the yearling?"

"People fortunate to be in my situation, we search for ways to USE our money, not just give it away. USE it."

"You think you can USE the yearling to do something good?"

"I do. Your sport is perfect for my scheme. You have a fistful of assets such as live animals, excitement, risk, and open spaces. Many other parts of your sport have me fired up."

"You think you can stretch the money you have earmarked for horse ownership?"

"I do."

"You think it would be good for harness racing?"

"I do."

"Obviously you've been working overtime with your millennium billionaire brain."

"I have. I'm toying with a wild plan. Before I give you the specifics, let me give you some information based on some data I have been studying and put you in my shoes."

"Information AND expensive new shoes, a win-win for me."

"When wealthy donate money, say to Parkinson's, most millennials do not like to write checks, giving like that is old school and inefficient. They like to be hands-on and make decisions. They like to participate and entice additional participation."

"Batman, this is harness horseracing, we're not in the fundraising business. In fact, you could call horse ownership and gambling on horses a fund-burning business."

"My idea is not a fundraiser. This is an unusual use of a donation. The goal is to help the receivers, the Parkinson's community, and not just financially. As a giver, I want to feel good about my endeavor. I want to try to create a useful prototype for other potential givers."

"You don't want your money to go down a rabbit hole?"

"Right, and I am optimistic that the experience could be a

benefit to horseracing with little disruption to business as usual."

"You're just shooting from the hip."

"No. There is data. The concept goes by several different names. One is 'experience-driven charitable environment.' Our only ask is that our audience gives us time, not money. The goal is a beta-tested plan that benefits all parties in the chain. Hopefully create a no-lose situation where engagement and partnerships are possible."

"On the back of a yearling racehorse in a dinky sport?"

He nodded, "Trust me, I'm a professional."

McIntosh advances four to Grassroots Championship

Woodbine Mohawk Park played host to the 2-year-old Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Grassroots Semi-Finals on Thursday (Sept. 20) and the youngsters put on a tremendous show for fans, with five of the eight races decided by less than one length.

The 2-year-old trotting colts set the tone in the first \$20,000 contest as the division's point leaders **A Royal Line** and Royale Elite battled tooth and nail down the stretch. A Royal Line had controlled the tempo for much of the race and Royale Elite appeared to have him beat at the top of the stretch, but A Royal Line fought back and put a head in front as the trotters reached the wire in 1:59. Favorite LA Magic was three lengths behind the leaders in third and Northern Tailwind and Fitzgibbons also advanced to the Sept. 29 Grassroots Championship.

"I thought A Royal Line fought hard, he was beat and he came back," said trainer Bob McIntosh. "I was pretty proud of him."

McIntosh bred and owns the son of Royalty For Life and Direct Dial with Dave Boyle of Bowmanville and Mardon Stables of Loretto, ON and Paul MacDonell piloted the gelding to his fourth lifetime win.

McIntosh, who watched the Semi-Finals from his vehicle on the way home from the Little Brown Jug in Delaware, OH, had reason to celebrate again following the second trotting colt Semi-Final. With Phil Hudon filling in for the scheduled Bob McClure, **Judge Ken** got away sharply from Post 7 and rang up fractions of :27.1, :57.2 and 1:27.3 on the way to a 1:57.4 score. Priceless Ruler finished one-half length back in second and favorite Cousin Peter was hot on his heels in third. LMC Picasso and Lariat Seelster also advanced to next weekend's final.

"Pretty proud of both colts, they were gritty, they were good," said McIntosh, who bred and owns the son of Justice Hall and Barbie And Ken in partnership with Boyle and C S X Stables of Liberty Center, OH. "It's been a good year. Hopefully we can finish it off with a bang."

McIntosh's trotting fillies Splurge On Me and Nifty Trick also advanced to the Championship. Splurge On Me made an early break leaving from Post 10, but recovered to finish fifth behind heavy favorite **At Will**, who stopped the teletimer at

1:58.1. Eramosa Magic was three and three-quarter lengths back in second, Galaxy Seelster was third and P L Molly fourth. Sylvain Filion piloted Kadabra daughter At Will to the win for trainer Julie Walker of Carlisle and her partners, breeder Layhoon Chan Brunner of Etobicoke and Ronald Piers of Georgetown, ON.

Nifty Trick finished second to **Rebellious Lady**, who sprinted down the stretch to a three and three-quarter length victory in 1:59.1. Royaltys Pearl was third and Pyrrha and Luckyjohanna completed the top five. Scott Young crafted the win for his father, trainer Bob Young, and owner Hugh Fitzpatrick of Guelph, ON.

"She's always a complete pro," said the driver, who was making his first-ever appearance in the post-season winner's circle. "She always shows up and does her job. For a two-year-old Angus Hall filly, she's a pleasure to drive."

The pacing filly divisions went to **Freya Seelster** and **Jessicas Legacy**, who both started from Post 1 with James MacDonald in the race bike.

Freya Seelster took command before the :56.3 half and opened up a gap on the field heading by the 1:25.2 three-quarters that runner-up Free Exchange was unable to close. The fan favorite hit the wire three-quarters of a length the best in 1:53.1. Sports Flix was third, Whitehaven Beach fourth and Saulsbrook Jessie fifth.

Mark Steacy trains Sunshine Beach daughter Freya Seelster for Katherine Steacy of Lansdowne, Shawn Steacy and Guy Haskell of Guelph, Ontario and Bertrand Gilhespy Stable of Edmonton, Alberta. Of the six freshmen Steacy started in Thursday's Semi-Finals, Freya Seelster was one of four that qualified for the Championships.

Jessicas Legacy enjoyed a pocket trip behind Lady Driver, stepping out in the stretch to claim the one and one-quarter length victory in 1:53.3. Favorite Shadow Sparks was second, Twin B Friendly third, Lady Driver settled for fourth and Buckingham was fifth. MacDonald crafted the win for trainer Anthony Beaton and owner-breeder Robert Hamather of Exeter, Ontario.

Chanting Hanover mounted a late charge to win the first \$20,000 pacing colt and gelding Semi-Final, which saw less than two lengths separate the top six horses. The Sportswriter son and driver Louis Philippe Roy hit the wire in 1:54.1, one half length ahead of The First Step and B Stoney. Mo Bettor was third and Ahi and Sports Hero finished in a

dead heat for fifth. Repentigny, Quebec resident Colin Johnson trains Chanting Hanover for Paul Johnson of Durham, England, and William Greenhorn and Andrew Dick of Stirling, Scotland.

The final honour of the evening went to fan favorites **Century Farroh** and driver Sylvain Filion, who powered to the front early and held on for a three-quarter length victory over Wager On Me. JMs Delight was third, Boys Turn fourth and Maintenance Man fifth. Dr. Ian Moore trains the pacing colt for Ratchford Stable NS of North Sydney, Nova Scotia and says the Ratchfords may not recognise the son of Mach Three when they arrive for next weekend's Championship.

"He's grown a lot. (Dave Ratchford) won't even know him when he sees him. He was just an average-sized colt when he came and now he's a nice, good-sized muscular colt, really solid, so we like him pretty good," said Moore of Century Farroh. "So hopefully he stays good for at least one more week."

The top five finishers from each two-year-old Semi-Final will be back at Woodbine Mohawk Park next Saturday, Sept. 29 for the Grassroots Championships.

Pretty Handsome in position to repeat as Grassroots champ

Reigning Grassroots champion **Pretty Handsome** delivered an emphatic statement at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Friday night, laying down a :27.4 final quarter in his 1:51.3 Semi-Final victory on a night when the wind slammed into each field as they turned for home.

"It's about a three second wind really," said driver Jody Jamieson, who won two of the eight Semi-Finals, including the other three-year-old colt event. "So the trip (Jonathan) Drury's horse went was monstrous."

Drury and Pretty Handsome left smartly from Post 5 in the second \$20,000 pacing colt Semi-Final and were comfortably in control by the :28 quarter. Unchallenged through a :56.3 half and 1:23.4 three-quarters, Pretty Handsome seemed completely unfazed by the wind that took the steam out of many of the evening's pacesetters. Rather than slowing, the Mach Three gelding powered down the stretch to a nine and one-quarter length victory. Luka Shenko and Shadow Moon completed the top three, with Phantom Seelster and Gideon

Seelster also advancing to next week's championship.

"Actually, he didn't surprise me tonight," said Andrew McCabe, who trains Pretty Handsome for owner Glenview Livestock Ltd. of Wallenstein. "A lot of horses that were leaving out into the wind and then finishing into the wind as well were getting tired, but he just seemed to accelerate in the stretch."

The win was Pretty Handsome's third straight and makes him a perfect four-for-four in Grassroots action this season. A two-time Grassroots winner at two, Pretty Handsome was not the favorite in last year's final and was awarded the title when Phantom Seelster was placed from first to ninth for causing interference. Second across the line, Pretty Handsome was elevated to first. With the other 2-year-old title holders failing to advance to this year's finals, the gelding is the only horse with an opportunity to repeat as champion.

Hoping to prevent Pretty Handsome from repeating will be the other Semi-Final winner, **When You Dance**, who used a late sprint to score his 1:54.2 victory. Pocket-sitter Yacht Seelster was second while pacesetter and fan favorite Casimir Richie P settled for third. JM Jack Of Hearts and Stock also advanced.

Jody Jamieson piloted When You Dance to the win for trainer Ben Wallace and his partners Daniel Plouffe of Bromont, QC and Birnam Wood Farms of Boca Raton, FL. Like Pretty Handsome When You Dance is undefeated in Grassroots action this season, winning two regular season events prior to his Semi-Final victory.

"He's just been a nice horse all year for us," said Wallace of the long-legged pacer. "He's had a great summer and we're looking forward to next week."

Jamieson's other victory came in the pacing filly division with favorite **Neon Moon**, who turned for home so far ahead of her peers she was able to ease up in the stretch and still hit the wire six and one-quarter lengths the best in 1:54.4. Sunday Afternoon finished second, Lady Bubbles was third, Mittany Nicole fourth and Enchanted Eva rounded out the finalists in fifth.

"She's a beast," said Jamieson, who drives the Sportswriter filly for owner/trainer Jack Darling of Cambridge, ON. "She's likely a Gold contender, but that division is so tough she's taking the road less travelled. With no bad luck, she should win the Grassroots Final."

Jonathan Drury earned his second Semi-Final win in the other pacing filly contest, guiding **Machnhope** to a 1:54.2 victory over Princess Abie W and Azure Seelster. Sharks Summrshandy and I Shadow U rounded out the top five. Bill Robinson trains the Mach Three daughter for CMR Farms of Hagersville, David Serwatak of Hamilton and BC Reichheld Stables of Caledonia, ON.

In the sophomore trotting colt Semi-Finals, **Say You Do** was also untroubled by the wind, pulling away from the field in the stretch to record a 12-length victory in 1:58. T Barr finished second in spite of broken equipment, Legend Within was third, Daylon Phantom fourth and Sicario fifth.

"He's a big strong colt that wasn't bothered by the windy conditions tonight," said driver Paul MacDonell. "He'll be a factor in the final next week."

MacDonell crafted the Kadabra gelding's third lifetime win for trainer Stephen Oldford, Oldford Racing LLC of Port Huron and Gene Oldford Farms LLC of St. Clair, MI.

The other trotting colt Semi-Final went to favorite **Jammin Jack** and driver James MacDonald in 1:59.2. Mister Magic was second, Delcrest Holiday third, Takter fourth and Northern Ruler finished fifth. Mark Steacy trains Angus Hall son Jammin Jack for Hutt Racing Stable of Paoli, Pennsylvania.

The trotting filly Semi-Finals went to **Stormont Charlotte** and **Zorgwijk Sophia**.

Stormont Charlotte trotted to a personal best 1:57.2, finishing four lengths ahead of favorite Hopes Solo and pacesetter Ezee Tiguan. Magics Lucky Charm and Gradabra also advanced to the final. Sylvain Filion piloted the Justice Hall daughter to the win for trainer John Gouveia and owner Alan Fair of Ancaster, ON.

Favorite Zorgwijk Sophia sailed to a 1:59 victory, five and one-half lengths ahead of Melanie G and Shotgun Sally. Stormont Chef and Gotta Pay To Play were well back in fourth and fifth. Doug McNair drove both Zorgwijk Sophia and Ezee Tiguan for trainer Lyle MacArthur and owners Linda Wellwood of St. George Brant and Tammy Aspden of Caistor Centre and will have to choose between the two for the final.

"Sophia is a nice little filly to drive," McNair said. "The other filly is different. Once you start her up she's tricky to get relaxed."

McNair has until Tuesday to make his decision, when the top five finishers from all of the two and three-year-old

Semi-Finals will be entered in the post-position draw for the finals. The eight Grassroots champions will be crowned Saturday, Sept. 29 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

McNair to replace Roy in NDC

Doug McNair, Canada's Driver of the Year in 2017, will take the spot of Louis-Philippe Roy in the National Driving Championship on Wednesday, Sept. 26 at Grand River Raceway.

McNair, who finished third in the Ontario Regional Driving Championship on May 16 at The Raceway at Western Fair District, was automatically offered the spot when Roy, who finished second, withdrew from the event on Friday afternoon.

Upon receiving the offer, McNair immediately jumped at the opportunity.

"It's my first National Championship," said McNair. "It is a tough way to earn the spot, and I do feel for Louis. I haven't seen the horses I'll be driving yet but I'm excited and pretty sure I've got a good shot."

"It's a good rebound of my bad day yesterday," McNair said, referring to the placing (from first to fourth) of Stay Hungry in the second elimination of yesterday's Little Brown Jug. Stay Hungry was ultimately scratched from the final.

Roy's withdrawal was the result of racing commitments he felt he had to fulfil on Tuesday, Sept. 25. In addition to other drives, he will drive Shower Play in the \$125,000 Ontario Sires Stakes Gold Final at Mohawk Racetrack. Drivers are required to participate in all promotional, charitable and media events related to the National Driving Championship, on both Tuesday and Wednesday.

"Unfortunately I'll have to give up my chance to represent Canada in Sweden," said Roy. "It's not an easy decision, but I think it's the best thing to do for my career and my business."

Roy's withdrawal came shortly after the draft took place for National Driving Championship horses. Because of that, McNair has agreed to drive the horses originally selected by Roy.

In addition to being the O'Brien Award winner as Canada's top driver last year, McNair currently has 242 wins and \$4,384,381 in earnings this season. He will join the seven

other drivers competing in Wednesday's NDC, including Trevor Henry who won this year's Ontario Regional Driving Championship.

Pocketed by Winston early, **Wheels On Fire** got his revenge late when he blew by Winston to score in L51, fastest division in Saturday's \$75,000 Keystone Classic at The Meadows.

The stake for 3-year-old colt and gelding pacers was contested over three splits, with **No Easy Day** and **Shadow Cat** taking the other divisions. Trainer Ron Burke enjoyed a Keystone Classic double with **Wheels On Fire** and **No Easy Day**.

Wheels On Fire dueled with Winston from the gate but retreated to the two hole for Mike Wilder.

"He's a big horse, and he's pretty aggressive," Wilder said. "But once I got him settled down in the hole, he was great. In the last turn, I thought he couldn't lose. When I pulled him, he just exploded. He's very athletic for the size of him."

In the lane, the **Somebeachsomewhere**—Ab Fab gelding roared by outside to down Winston by a length, with another Burke trainee, **Aleppo Hanover**, third. Bill Donovan campaigns **Wheels On Fire**, who won for the eighth time in 18 career starts.

No Easy Day worked out a similar pocket trip before out-kicking his stablemate, **Go West Go Fast**. In the stretch and defeating him by 2 lengths in 1:51.2. Yupper completed the ticket. Before getting his picture taken, **No Easy Day** had to survive an inquiry for a possible pylon violation.

"He won from last on **Adios Day** in 1:50, so the option to take back was there if it looked a little crazy getting away," said winning driver Tony Hall. "But there was kind of an even flow, so it looked like I could get away quickly. He had a lot of go."

Thomas Dillon owns **No Easy Day**, a **Somebeachsomewhere**—**Wish All You Want** gelding.

Shadow Cat was unhurried early, but when he tipped off the live cover of **Kwik Talkin** for Aaron Merriman, he was much the best, prevailing by 2-1/4 lengths in 1:52.1.

Daddyofemall rallied for second while **Kwik Talkin** was third.

"He's big and gangly and doesn't steer the best," Merriman said. "He got a little bit green when he got by his cover. He doesn't have that knockout punch yet, but he has a lot of ability."

John Butenschoen conditions the **Somebeachsomewhere**—**Shady Past** gelding, who completed the Keystone Classic sweep for his daddy and extended his career bankroll to \$123,574 for William Wiswell, Jean Goehlen and Eugene Schick.

Liberty Bell tests at Harrah's Philadelphia

The Liberty Bell stakes series continued on Friday at Harrah's Philadelphia with action for 2-year-old colts, with each gait contesting three \$30,000 divisions.

Among the pacing set, it was the **Western Ideal**—**My Little Artist** colt **Mangogh** who first visited Victory Lane, working out a pocket trip for driver Eric Carlson behind favored **Sugar Factory**, then rallying up the inside to catch that rival by a length while equaling his lifetime mark of 1:53.4. Bruce Saunders trains the winner of three of his last five starts for **M And L Of Delaware LLC** and **M & M Harness Racing LLC**.

Southwind Ozzi got the other kind of perfect trip – second-over – in taking a maiden mark of 1:53.2 for driver Mike Simons and trainer Bill MacKenzie in his Liberty Bell section. It was obvious on the far turn that the son of **Somebeachsomewhere**—**Southwind Solara** was right up on the bit and ready to go, and indeed he stormed home in 56 to be four lengths clear at the finish for owners Vincent Ali and Alma lafelice.

The **Sweet Lou**—**Shark Lightning** colt **Love Me Some Lou**, still the fastest juvenile of the year on a 5/8-mile track at 1:50.4, charged uncovered before and around the far turn to get a stretch advantage, then withstood favored **Captain Victorious** rallying up the inside to take down a ¾ length victory in 1:53. Corey Callahan, who drove him in that season's record mile, also guided "Lou" today for trainer Tom Cancelliere and owner John Cancelliere.

Among the trotters, the **Donato Hanover**—**Lady Holiday** colt **Holiday Hanover** was kept out of trouble by driver Jordan

Stratton, then kicked home first 1½ lengths clear while going in 1:58 for his first lifetime victory. D.R. Ackerman owns and trains the youngster, who had had trouble in his previous starts but today eluded racing misfortune and proved the strongest late.

The Cantab Hall–Upside Hanover colt **Klutzy** had to mount a first-over challenge from last in his division, but he proved equal to the challenge, grinding down favored pacesetter Stonebridge Symba and then fending off the late rush of Ginger Tree Skyr by 1½ lengths in 1:57.4. Corey Callahan, notching a win on each gait, handled the catch-driving assignment behind Klutzy and made the most of it for trainer Julie Miller and Stroy Inc.

In the third section, sent off at 7-5 were both the Explosive Matter–Phaeton gelding **Explosivebreakaway**, a full brother to top sophomore filly Phaetosive, and the Muscle Hill–Bluff colt Summit In Sight, a \$300,000 yearling making his career debut. The pedigrees showed on the racetrack, as early leader Explosivebreakaway left Summit In Sight go to the lead at the 3/8 and set soft fractions, then rallied inside in a :28.4 kicker to just get by his main foe by half a length in 1:59. Tom Jackson guided the winner, now 5 3-2-0 for his brief career, for trainer Fred Grant, who is also co-owner with Janice Rubin, Steve Katz, and Murray Brown.

Why must horses retire at 15?

Why is 15 the age standardbreds must retire in the USA? This is a rule that has been on the books for over 60 years. Common sense tells me, but apparently not the USTA, that advancements in veterinary medicine, nutrition, breeding, training, shoeing, as well as track conditions must have extended the career span of a trotter or pacer in all that time. Shouldn't the horse be the one to decide when it's time to hang it up? In my opinion, if there wasn't an expiration date on a horse's career, you would see more aged horses racing well past the end of their 14th year. Without a clock ticking, trainers and owners would manage the older horse differently. The way it is now, if an older horse develops a physical issue, it is not given the proper amount of time to remedy the issue, as time in most cases is not an available option due to this ridiculous and antiquated rule. Hence, most older horses are raced into the ground and then discarded. If the rule did not exist, a horse would be given the time it needed, as it would still be of value. Also, the industry faces a perception of animal abuse by many factions. Wouldn't it be of benefit to show the world that our sport is not compromising to a horse's health by racing older horses? This would distance us in perception from the horrific rate of catastrophic injuries that occur in thoroughbred and quarter horse racing. I challenge you to pick up a racing form and find a 10 or 11 year old thoroughbred that is still racing. There certainly are not many. In my opinion, if a horse is healthy and sound, age is irrelevant. If this rule is abolished, over time you will see older horses careers being extended at a racetrack near you and not in someone's backyard stumbling over an old washing machine and Chevy truck bumper because let's face the dirty truth, there aren't enough good homes out there for our retired horses. By extending their career, it may alleviate to a point the daunting task of finding a new home for these beautiful animals. How else can striking this rule benefit our sport? I am sure everyone is

aware of the current racehorse shortage that seems to be growing on a daily basis. Forcing healthy and sound racehorses to retire seems extremely counterproductive in light of this shortage. I come from the horse jumping industry and I can tell you, most jumpers don't peak until 17 or 18 years of age.

Now when it comes to racing in the old wooden shaft race bikes, again it's an idea that needs to be looked at. For elimination and finals, the track should stipulate all eliminations and finals will be raced with the wooden shaft sulky and combined with the start moved back it should negate both inside post bias and the open draw problem, I also believe that the track should bear the cost of the wooden shaft bikes. In my opinion, the movement towards speed has, and always will be about the money and directly linked to the breeders, they want the fastest stallions standing at their facility, the buyers who put up the most hope to win substantially, and the better the black type in the book can reap the rewards after racing. The manufactures of these new speed bikes are only too happy to oblige the breeders and purchasers, and with every win and a new race mark means continued success for their business. You'll notice that I haven't mentioned racing, and that's because every aspect falls under the racing shingle but the actual racing is so far removed from the business and the money it's why the sport is in trouble. It reminds me of the Great Depression everyone trying to be first in line for a job or to eat, forget about tomorrow, let's worry about today first. It's only an opinion from someone who has been through it all and was vocal along the way and after 50 years, still no one is listening and nothing has changed.
