Delaware, Ohio resident Chris
Page posted an emotional victory
in the 77th Little Brown Jug by
driving supplemental Ohio-bred
entry Bythemissal to victory for the
Burke Brigade. It was Burke's fourth
Jug win in eight years and second
straight.

Chris Page was 11 years old when he clung to the chain-link fence around the Delaware County Fair racetrack and watched Magical Mike win the 1994 Little Brown Jug. From that day forward, the Ohio native fantasized that someday it might be him hoisting the Jug trophy in that winner's circle.

After driving in 36,028 races, Page's childhood dream finally came true Thursday.

Page, a resident of Delaware, was mobbed in the winner's circle by nearly 200 family and friends after he steered favorite Bythemissal to victory in the \$641,550 Little Brown Jug final. Trained by Ron Burke, **Bythemissal**, won by three-quarters of a length over Fourever Boy and Night Hawk in 1:51.1.

"I can't even put it into words," Page said. "It's just a whole bunch of emotions. I've been coming to the Little Brown Jug since I was a little guy and standing on the fence cheering. To actually win, it's just the icing on the cake for my career."

The Burke Brigade in the winner's circle after winning the Jug in back-to-back years and the fourth time in the last eight years.

Bythemissal, just the second Ohio-bred pacer to win the Little Brown Jug after BJ Scoot in 1988, has now won 10 races in his 12-race career and earned \$830,525. He became the third horse in Jug history to win after a supplemental payment, following in the hoofprints of Wiggle It Jiggleit in 2015 and Courtly Choice in 2018.

The gelding was the pre-race favorite by virtue of wins this year in the \$350,000 Delvin Miller Adios and \$300,000 Max C. Hempt Memorial. Few observers, however, would have expected the son of Downbytheseaside, purchased as a yearling for \$135,000 from the 2020 Lexington Select Sale, to be anyone's best Jug shot when he started the year.

While most horses gain experience for a tough 3-year-old campaign by racing at age 2, Bythemissal suffered an injury that sidelined him until the late fall of 2021. He finally showed a flash of potential by winning his first race Nov. 30 for trainer Josh Green and owner Erik Good.

The gelding moved to Burke's barn early in 2022 after Good sold shares to Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi and Rich Lombardo Racing. The pacer soon proved his value, capturing eight of his first 10 races and beating many of the best horses in his class.

"When Josh sent him to me, he said he was the real deal," Burke said. "When [Bythemissal] started training down, I said he was the best horse in the barn, and he showed it."

If anyone knows a good horse, it is Burke, who has conditioned winners of more than 13,000 races and \$288.6 million in purses.

Burke won the 2021 Jug with Lou's Pearlman to cap a year in which the trainer was also inducted into the Harness Racing Hall of Fame. Filibuster Hanover in 2017 and Limelight Beach in 2014 also put Burke in the Jug winner's circle.

Unlike Burke's previous horses, however, Bythemissal was not kept eligible to compete in the Jug. Lucky for his connections, Jug officials changed the rules in 2022 to allow any ineligible horse to compete for a supplemental fee — set at \$45,000.

"We are pretty game bunch," Burke said of the ownership team before the race. "It does not take much to get them to try and

do something neat. He is as good as any 3-year-old I have had to this point. He really is a special horse. He deserves this shot."

Bythemissal dominated in the first elimination heat, taking the lead right off the gate and pulling away from the field by four lengths at the finish of a 1:51.3 mile. Night Hawk was second and Atlas Hanover was third.

"He was super," second trainer Mickey Burke said of the elimination win. "The horse went exactly the way Chris wanted to drive him and he paced home on his own. Chris says he couldn't have been any better."

Fourever Boy moved into the final by virtue of his elimination heat victory, though it was far from easy. The Dexter Dunn-driven pacer was parked much of the race before pulling clear in the stretch, winning by 1 ½ lengths in 1:51.4 to give trainer Tim Twaddle his first Jug heat victory. Six Feet Apart was second and Gulf Shores was third.

"It's kind of like an out-of-body experience," Twaddle said. "Everybody dreams of being in the Jug and it's so hard to have a horse who is good enough to compete at this level. He just really special."

The top eight finishers moved on to the final, and Fourever Boy shot out to an early lead, while Page tucked Bythemissal right behind the leader through fractions of :27.1 and :55.3. When the field rounded the three-quarters in 1:24.1, the race was on. Bythemissal had the lead midway through the stretch and neither he nor Page were going to give up an inch.

"You need to be aggressive," Burke said. "You're not going to win here just watching the race. You got to be in it."

The victory was Burke's second Jug in two years, and it puts the trainer in historic company as just the third person in history to train four Jug winners, joining Hall of Famers Billy Haughton with six and Stanley Dancer with four.

"The thing is, I'm not done," Burke said. "I've got to catch these guys. I don't like being second. I've got a lot more to go. But I'm thrilled to win this one... because it gave Chris his first, and he's our quy."

Page was equally excited to win with Burke, who he called, "the best trainer, not standardbreds but even thoroughbreds." He recognized that the partnership has lifted them both to lofty heights.

"He's took me from zero to a hero in my career," Page said. "Like in the movie 'Willy Wonka,' I punched a golden ticket with Ronnie."

The sun was setting on the Delaware Fairgrounds as Page jogged Bythemissal back to the barn, accepting congratulations every step of the way.

Waiting for him, standing by the chain-link fence was his 21-month-old son, Carter, who had just witnessed his first Jug dressed in mini white and blue colors

that matched his father.

When asked if history might repeat itself a few decades in the future, Page just grinned.

"I don't know," Page said. "Whatever he does, I hope it makes him feel like I do right now."




The field raced in pairs past the three-quarters in 1:23.4. Treacherous Dragon looked like she had nowhere to go, but

Former standardbred trainer Richard Banca was sentenced to 30 months in federal prison after pleading guilty to one count of drug adulteration and misbranding. Banca was among the more than two dozen individuals nabbed in a widespread investigation into doping in thoroughbred and standardbred racing.

Banca was also fined \$10,000 and has been ordered to pay a forfeiture of \$120.975.

Rene Allard, Thomas Guido III, Donato Poliseno and Louis Grasso were named in the same indictment as Banca and have pled

guilty. They are scheduled to be sentenced at later dates.

The government had asked the judge to sentence Banca to 36 months while Banca's defense team had asked for a sentence of home confinement followed by probation.

"Richard Banca was a prominent racehorse trainer whose success was founded on fraud and deceit. Banca's racing program – which he built and helmed – was predicated on a scheme to obtain and administer illegal, unsafe, and unapproved performance enhancing drugs to racehorses under his control. Banca orchestrated this deceit in service of greed, namely, to increase the odds that his horses would win races, thus earning him greater fees and income," the prosecutors wrote in their pre-sentence filing.

The government's pre-sentence filing continued: "First, it is not the case that the defendant's crime was the result of a single lapse in judgment, confined in time and scope. The defendant engaged in a years-long, sophisticated, and lucrative scheme to corruptly win horse races. Until his arrest, Banca earned his livelihood through his 'doping program', which touched all the horses under his care and control. And that doping program carried serious risks to the health of the horses under his care. Banca's claim that his horses did not 'suffer any injury' as a result of his doping is simply incorrect."

Banca wrote a letter to the court apologizing for his deeds. It read: "I would like to start with telling you I'm sorry for what I've done. I'm sorry for breaking the law. I'm sorry for what this has done to my family. I never thought I would ever be in trouble with the law. I know I have made mistakes, but I have taken the last 2 ½ years to do right."

When Banca was indicted in March of 2020, the court documents regarding his case include a deposition from FBI agent Bruce Turpin, who linked Banca to Grasso and Conor Flynn, who were among the 27 indicted. Turpin testified that Banca's property in Middletown, NY was searched and that the FBI found a number of illegal substances and handwritten notes with instructions on how to administer those drugs. Turpin laid out a scenario where Flynn, Grasso and Banca worked together to illegally administer drugs to horses.

"I have learned that Grasso has, on multiple occasions, supplied Flynn with adulterated and misbranded performanceenhancing drugs for Flynn to administer – or deliver to others to administer – to racehorses," Turpin testified.

In further testimony, Turpin reported: "Based on my discussions with an agent who has spoken with a confidential source, I have learned that Flynn has stated, in substance and in part, that Flynn administers horses owned, trained, or otherwise under Banca's control, with PEDs at Banca's direction.

In 2011, Banca was sanctioned by the New York Racing and Wagering Board for Oxymetazoline violations and given a 90-day suspension and a \$1,000 fine.

Banca has won 1,695 races. After never having more than 82 winners in a year, his win total shot up to 174 in 2015 and he won 200 races in 2016. He was the leading trainer at Yonkers at the time of his arrest. Allard was in second place at the time.

In a related development, Lisa Giannelli, an associate of Dr. Seth Fishman, has appealed her conviction and sentencing. Giannelli, one of only a handful among those indicted on doping-related charges to take their case to trial, was sentenced to 30 months in prison and was also ordered to pay a fine of \$100,000 and to forfeit \$900,000.

Fishman was sentenced to 30 years and is currently locked up in a Florida prison.

Coming off a win streak spanning two Ontario Sires stakes Gold legs and the Peaceful Way elimination and final, Righteous Resolve (Resolve–Motown Muscle) easily extended her divisional dominance in one of two \$83,098 Champlain Stake filly events last Thursday night at her home track.

Trained by John Bax and out of former Bax trainee Motown Muscle (3, 1:53.4s; \$447,945), Righteous Resolve smashed the stake record and became Canada's fastest 2-year-old trotter of 2022 with her 1:53.1s mile. Her stablemate, Proud To Be Lindy, led to the :27.4 opening quarter and closed for place, getting within six-and-a-half lengths of the longgone winner. There was simply no catching Righteous Resolve after driver Paul MacDonell sent her third-over from fourth approaching the :57.1 half. Shiny New Penny briefly took command, right before MacDonell's filly circled with ease and opened up on the final turn. Looking relaxed at three-quarters in 1:24.2, she needed no urging from her driver, who kept glancing over his shoulder down the stretch, vigilant for closers. None came close.

Matt Bax takes Righteous Resolve for most of her training miles. He praised MacDonell's winning drive: "Paul does a great job managing the young horses, and he knows that there's a lot more starts to come, so I think he shut her down, down the stretch and just did what was comfortable for her."

Matt, son of trainer John, drove Quite Fast (Walner—Juanitas Fury) to a place finish in the card's first Champlain filly event. She left quickly from the outside post to make front and led until strides from the wire, when Milliondollarwall and Yannick Gingras came calling late in the 1:56.1s mile.

"She's a homebred and she improves a little bit each week," Matt said. "She's got a lot of heart, and there's nothing wrong with having a Walner filly, either."

Another John Bax trainee, Its Your Choice, finished third behind Ouite Fast for driver James MacDonald.

The day after the draw for the Mohawk Million, Matt Bax explained why Righteous Resolve's name was conspicuously absent from the 10-horse field, though Bax trainees Proud To Be Lindy and Oh Look Magic are both heading to the gate.

"I think it just came down to there were a lot of opportunities. I'm sure anyone would have given up a slot for (Righteous Resolve), to make a deal, but at the end of the day, the owners felt that maybe it wasn't the best thing to do for the longevity of her [career]. She still has two more OSS races and the Breeders Crown up here."

The filly is owned by Bet Max Stables Inc. of Casco, MI and Benenati Inc., Clinton Township, MI. Bax said they considered the bigger picture to be the longevity of the filly's career.

"They looked at that, and racing against the colts, and thought, 'You know what? Maybe it's best to sit this one out'... It's a tough

Over \$800,000 raised to date for local charities! thing to do when money's on the line like that. But this might be the best course for the horse, in the long run. We support whatever they want to do, and hopefully it works out in the long run."

Matt knows Righteous Resolve and family well

"She definitely has the pedigree there. To say that she was going to be as good as she is..." He paused, then offered his take on her rapid ascension: "Even week-to-week, training her, it's a little tough to believe. When you have that grit on the track, and she goes out there and performs the way she does... Yeah, I wouldn't say I expected that from her training miles."

He does see parallels to Motown Muscle's other foals, however.

"We bought the brother the year before, [2021 O'Brien Two-Year-Old Trotting Colt of the Year] Duly Resolved [3, 1:54.1s; \$611,755]... We've also had the sister out of the mare as well, Bright Eyes M [3,1:53.0s; \$239,589; now owned by Menhammar Stuteri of Sweden].

"I don't know if it's a trait of the family, because Duly Resolved was the same way, but they're all very smart. It's a very smart family. It's just 1, 2, 3 —they have the bike on in two days. Very easy to break, very smart. So that goes a long way when you're racing as a 2-year-old too, to be that smart. They make it easy."

The Baxes were naturally interested in Motown Muscle's 2020 foal.

"We heard that [the owners] had a full-sister Resolve yearling, so we talked to them because they're getting all these breeders' awards for Duly Resolved in the OSS," said Matt. "We kept in contact and asked them what they were doing with this filly, whether they were putting her in the sale or if they wanted to sell her privately. Fortunately for us, they kept us in mind and said, 'Well, we're going to keep her, but would you guys like to train her?"

John Bax took Righteous Resolve and a handful of other young horses to train at the Palema Trotting Center in Vero Beach, FL over the colder Canadian months.

"We broke her up here first before she went down to Florida." He doesn't head down until the first of December, so we break everything here and decide what we want to send down," said Matt, who worked with the stable's remaining 14-15 horses in Campbellville, ON last winter. He said caretaker Lianne Head and regular turnout friend, maiden trotting filly Its Your Choice (Muscle Mass-Choice Hall), help keep Righteous Resolve on the right track, mentally and physically.

TIP TOP CAT: PERFECT TIMING FOR THE **METRO PACE**

in a non-stakes start there Sept. 13), the Campbellville, ON-based trainer has something to celebrate. His 31-1 Metro Pace elimination winner Tip Top Cat gets closer to Saturday's (Sept. 24) final at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

"I thought he'd got in with a really tough bunch there, but it worked," said McNair. "It was a perfect trip for him, the way it worked out for him. He got used fairly hard leaving the gate too. so he did a little bit of the work."

Tip Top Cat (Always B Miki-Western Top Cat) left from post #7, ambitiously circling then-undefeated 2-5 favorite Stockade Seelster and 5-2 second-choice Tickertape Hanover to make front before the first turn. Driver Doug McNair opted to let those two rivals battle for the lead, backing down to third as they sparred to the :27 opening quarter.

Tip Top Cat was single-file third, his driver flat in the bike, at the :55 half. The backfield was in motion to his outside at the 1:23 three-quarters, leaving McNair with one best route to success – "McNair Lane," as some dub the inside path down the Mohawk stretch. The late-blooming colt sprinted past Tickertape Hanover (second) and Stockade Seelster (third) in a :26.3 closing quarter.

"He went up there twice," said Gregg, Doug's father. "The first time, there wasn't any room there, and he kind of had to wait a few more lengths, then it opened up enough for him to get through."

The one-length victory was his second in six career starts, the 1:50.1s mile a new personal best.

"When we qualified him, he was probably one of the better-looking horses coming out for the 2-year-old [Mohawk] qualifiers, in the spring," Gregg said. Tip Top Cat won his June 25 qualifier in 1:55.1s, but encountered a setback.

"He looked like he was one of the top colts up here, then he got sick. It seemed like a long time before we got him racing. It was a month before he even started."

When he made his pari-mutuel debut July 26, the colt closed from post #10 for place. He broke his maiden for regular driver Doug McNair with an off-the-pace 1:54.2s effort on Aug. 11.

Tip Top Cat came into stakes competition late, finishing seventh in the Aug. 27 Nassagaweya at his home track. A week later, Gregg said he was impressed by the colt's sixth-place trip (despite interference) in the Champlain Stake.

"He raced big," said the trainer. "He was kind of out of it, but he did finish good, though. That's more the kind of horse I thought he was. It even surprised Doug a little bit. Not me though."

Stepping up last Saturday (Sept. 17) on the biggest stage for freshman pacers was a different story.

"As far as winning the Metro elimination, I wasn't looking for that. It surprised me that he won the Metro elimination... But we really did like that colt, training down."

Owners Scott Horner of Toronto, ON and Timothy Murray of Shawville, QC share ownership of the Pennsylvania-eligible colt, who was a \$50,000 Harrisburg purchase.


"I've had a few horses for Clay and Scott [Horner]. We were shopping for yearlings there last year and [Scott] was going after an Always B Miki filly," said Gregg. "He went really high on her. I think maybe he bid \$170,000 on that filly. Didn't get her. He wasn't at the sale, so he said to me, 'Go take a look at that colt and see if you like him.' I didn't pick the horse out of the catalog, but I went to look him over and called [Scott] back and said, 'Yeah, he's a nice-looking colt."

An improbable victory in the \$900,000 Metro Pace would be sweet vindication for Tip Top Cat's connections. Because of illness, "he missed all his stakes, pretty much," said trainer McNair. "He's eligible for the Kentucky Sire Stake; he comes from Hunterton Farm [Paris, KY]. The stakes were almost over by the time that he looked like he'd be competitive in them. He's got some Grand Circuit races in Lexington – I don't know if he's going or not – and he's also eligible to the Breeders Crown."

Gregg considers his trainee the likely fourth choice among Metro bettors. He expects strong repeat performances from Stockade Seelster, Tickertape Hanover, and first elimination winner Save America. He also expressed cautious optimism for his own colt's chances.

"There's a lot between now and Saturday night, so I hope things work out for him this week."

Handicapping the Woodbine Mohawk Saturday \$100,000 guaranteed Pick-5

As part of one of the best cards of the year, the Saturday Pick-5 at Woodbine Mohawk Park spans across all major stakes on the card, concluding with the Mohawk Million. Here are my thoughts for (hopefully) putting together a winning ticket.

RACE 6, \$525,000 SHE'S A GREAT LADY FINAL

There's only a few "must include" type horses throughout the Pick-5 sequence, and two of those are in this race, in what figures to be a showdown between elimination winners Charleston and Sylvia Hanover; both 2-year-old fillies with identical records. Charleston impressed last week upon arrival in his first start north of the border. The Pelling trainee came first up from fifth off a slow half, had the pocket horse pull in front of her, and it still didn't matter as she tracked that cover and then powered away late to win rather easily in the end. Likewise, Sylvia Hanover delivered as expected at odds of 1-9 where she controlled the pace through a pedestrian-like :57.3 half-mile split at which point no one was going to get to her; she was an even more impressive winner two back in the Champlain when she took her early career mark of 1:50.2.

I won't be reaching beyond those two, but if someone else were to win it would eliminate a massive share of Pick-5 tickets after the first leg. Some other fillies to at least consider as upset candidates include Horizontal who wasn't bad last week in her elimination, fending off two-hole pressure and only gave way late to Charleston. Bellisima Hanover had some late pace to offer from the pocket in her elimination after the race had already been settled; went a tough trip two back but is yet to figure out Sylvia Hanover. The exact same can be said for Caviart Diva, who fought that rival filly impressively all the way through the lane three back in the Eternal Camnation. She wasn't a factor last week, however. Treacherous Penny took a shot last week only to flatten out late.

RACE 7, \$350,000 ELEGANTIMAGE FINAL

It's hard to make a case to not include Warrawee Xenia. It's certainly possible she could break as she did in her both starts in August including the Hambletonian Oaks, but outside of that she's been brilliant. Last week was just another example of how these prep-type races are unbettable as Warrawee Xenia was raced from the pack in a paceless race at odds of 3-5 and trotted up a storm late to close in :26.2. Maybe the post 11 second tier creates issues?

Mon Cheval was the winner of that Warrawee Xenia race last week and now finally lands an inside post in a big race; she's seemed long overdue for that. She was handled aggressively last week and was strong; will need to be ever better now but that was an encouraging step forward. Raised By Lindy is perhaps still sorting herself out in her sophomore season. She couldn't track down Fashion Schooner nor hold off Jiggy Jog S from third last out at the Meadowlands, but there's no disgrace in either of those two things; took a lifetime mark two back at Lexington. Peyton Hanover surprised to take the "B" NJ Classic Final last out when she swept from loose third over cover; maybe is around if the pace sets up for her.Adare Castle threw in a rare clunker last week; likely back to speed tactics now but will have to get involved from an outside post. Mischievous Rose couldn't get close to Mon Cheval last week from the pocket but was able to hang out for second over the oncoming Warrawee Xenia.

RACE 8, \$900,000 METRO FINAL

This is another race that's going to have a clear favorite, this time in Save America. The Takter trainee has stormed through the 2-year-old stakes in Canada including the Nassagaweya, Champlain and then his Metro elimination last week when he moved uncovered from sixth and earned a measured win without too much anxiety; second time this year he's broken 1:50. This is a competitive group of frosh colts however, and there are reasons to go beyond just Save America for Pick-5 purposes.

Stockade Seelster went down in defeat last week for the first time in seven career starts, and that was a bit of a surprise. One race removed from that super OSS Gold win in 1:49.3, he took pressure in his Metro elimination early to rebuff a rival into the pocket and then again at the top of the stretch and ended up being passed late both to his inside and outside. He does land a great post on Saturday to potentially rebound. Tickertape Hanover matched strides with Stockade Seelster for much of their mile last week and looked like a winner for a moment in deep stretch. He was an impressive winner two back in the Nassagaweya and was runner-up to Save America three back. Tip Top Cat pulled off a shocker in his Metro elimination for team McNair and the aggressive handling paid off. After leaving early and securing a close, inside spot, the Always B Miki colt skimmed up the rail to win at odds of 31-1; anxious to see if he's that good again. Huntinthelastdolar was used

early in his elimination and was fair late, similar for Ace of Aces. Ants Marching will be a longshot in this final, but he did make a circling move around the final turn in his elimination and kept his momentum going well enough in the stretch. Moment Is Here continues to outrace his odds against the best 2-year-olds; deserves some respect.

RACE 9, \$615,000 CANADIAN TROTTING CLASSIC

This edition of the CTC for 3-year-old colts contains many of the usual suspects we've seen from over the past couple of seasons now and is probably the widest open of any race in this Pick-5 sequence.

Horses I wouldn't want to get beat by include a host of them, starting with Pretender. He's been quite good in his last three and has come to the form that I'm sure his connections had expected of him all year. He popped the two-hole early last out in the New Jersey Classic and was proved right as he gradually went on by and lasted to the wire in a compact field that included a win over 1-9 favorite Temporal Hanover. Branded By Lindy picked a good time to deliver, winning the \$400,000 KY Sires final last week at the Red Mile when he tracked down the cover of Rebuff. Keg Stand is another worth including, coming off two strong front-end tries for Takter. It looks like he'll pick up a new driver too in Todd McCarthy as Andy is listed on Pretender.

He hasn't been bad, but he hasn't intimidated anyone either. Simcoe winner Twin B Archie will get attention from the hometown crowd; faces some new and tough foes. Slay did surprise in the Dancer in July but outside of that I would be surprised. Fast As The Wind gave way last out in Lexington and now has post 10. Periculum will be a big longshot but did have some late trot to offer two weeks ago in that NJ Classic. Duly Resolved nearly pulled off a shocker on this night last year in the Mohawk Million; exits an encouraging try.

RACE 10, \$1,000,000 MOHAWK MILLION


This is the third edition of the Mohawk Million and fillies have been prominent in the first two years of the race. Of course, with super 2-year-old filly Righteous Resolve not entered in this race despite a smashing record score last out in the Champlain, this race looks open.

Favoritism may end up going slightly to Winners Bet. One of two Walner colts in here, he punched his ticket by winning the Wellwood two back when he rode the cover of International Man to edge by late for the win. Last week, he was used early from post 10 and floated many paths wide into the first turn before having to continue onward from fifth before eventually clearing to the lead. There was no shame in getting beat off that trip by pocket-sitting Gaines Hanover, but he'll need to bring his best. Another one to attract attention will be Oh Well. The New Jersey Sires Stakes and NJ Classic winner makes his Woodbine Mohawk debut for Melander and Tetrick; interesting to see how form translates.

From inside out for other possibilities, Proud To Be Lindy was pretty good last week in the Champlain where she showed speed and had decent trot after being shuffled back behind a gapper; did well to stave off a rival filly for second. Oh Look Magic went a tough trip in the Wellwood when she couldn't clear to the lead and dueled, rebounded nicely to beat fillies that included International Man in the Champlain. Yo Beth D invades from Indiana and has been thriving for Luther. Silly Me Hanover raced encouragingly last out in her first start since the Peaceful Way; connections seem to shine in spots like this. Dw's Point Man has had most of his success on the smaller tracks but he did win here at Woodbine Mohawk two back; needs to go faster. What An Angel was decent last out despite the big step up in class; moving in the right direction. Meet the field for the 2022 Mohawk Million

The third edition of the Mohawk Million will headline a \$3.6 million card of racing this Saturday (Sept. 24) at Woodbine Mohawk Park.



Started in 2020, the Mohawk Million is an event for 2-year-old trotters that follows a 'buy-in' format. A total of nine slots were available for purchase at the cost of \$100,000 (Cdn) each for entry in the \$1 million (Cdn) Mohawk Million. The 10th and final slot was awarded to the winner of the William Wellwood Memorial on Aug. 27.

The owners of the slots were not required to declare a 2-year-old trotter for the race until Monday at noon. Each slot is considered an entity that could be sold, traded or leased.

Just like in past years, several of the slot owners worked out private deals with their spot in the race. Owner Brad Grant has had the winning slot in both editions of the 'Million', securing a horse that he did not own in each victory.

Here is a breakdown of this year's slot owners and field.





Ken Warkentin is a beauty

According to the website **NCAA.com**, "beauty" is hockey slang for "a player who is loved not only for his skills, but for his personality. He is one of the coolest guys on the team and usually has great stories. He might also have the best flow on the team."

Sounds like a good term for newly minted Hall of Famer Ken Warkentin, who's living out his childhood dream, although he did have to trade skates for sulkies.

"I had this pipedream to be a play-by-play announcer in hockey or a color guy," said Warkentin. "And then I found this thing on the side, called harness racing."

At 14-years-old, Warkentin saw his first race at his hometown track, Greenwood Raceway in Toronto. And, at that time, he remembers reading the sports section of his local newspaper,

the *Toronto Star*, and responding to a feature that offered young fans the opportunity to meet a sports personality.

So, he wrote a letter to the newspaper because he wanted to meet Greenwood's track announcer and shortly thereafter was contacted by Jim Lampman, long-time publicity director for the Ontario Jockey Club.

"And I met Earl Lennox and I spent a whole night there," said Warkentin. "And he said, 'If you ever want to come up and call qualifiers, you can.' Which I did."

While at college, Warkentin got a summer job at Greenwood working in the race office and calling the baby races.

One night, when Lennox was on vacation, Jack Stephens was scheduled to call but was running late, so the judges asked Warkentin to give the changes and do the post parade.

As they were moving behind the gate, Stephens finally walked in and Warkentin handed him the mic and went to leave.

"He says 'Hey, you know these, right?" said Warkentin. "I say 'Yeah, I think so.' And he hands me the mic and I did the first race."

A columnist from Toronto's *Globe and Mail* newspaper got wind of the story and wrote about the aspiring announcer who got his big chance.

Warkentin grew up a few streets over from Flamboro Downs track announcer Wayne Reed.

"I would drive to Flamboro and he would let me call two races a night and do post parades," said Warkentin. "I wasn't getting paid but he was giving me good exposure."

When Reed retired, Warkentin became the Flamboro announcer from 1982-90, before moving to the States.

Following a one-year stint as publicity director and backup announcer at Ohio's Northfield Park, Warkentin got his dream job when he was hired to work at The Meadowlands in 1991.

It's got to be fun and if it's not fun, find something else. I really love the pressure. Put me in that spot. I'm prepared. I'm ready to go. Now, you can put the light on. Put me there. I want to be there. I want that pressure.

He's now in his 31st year at the mecca of harness racing and is quick to point out that through the whole of his tenure, he has been part of a terrific on-air team that's included John Bothe, Dave Brower, Shades Demsky, Edison Hatter, Bob Heyden, Dave Johnson, Dave Little, Sam McKee and Jessica Otten.

Warkentin has called and done TV work at many different tracks throughout his career, and in addition to The Big M, for over the last dozen years, he's been part of broadcasts from Red Shores at the Charlottetown Driving Park on Prince Edward Island, one of Canada's Maritime Provinces.

"Because The Meadowlands is not racing at that particular time it allows him to do some work on our signature events," said Lee Drake, manager of racing, brands, and broadcast for Red Shores. "The winner is really us and our team. Ken is a true professional. He always comes prepared. And he's a true delight for the customers and also the horsepeople get along great with him.

"When Ken comes to Prince Edward Island, he's here to work and whether it's on the broadcast or backfilling for [announcer] Vance Cameron when he has to go to the booth and call some races or hosting something with me, he's just a pro and that's why he's going into the Hall of Fame."

Last week, while out taking a walk, Warkentin got the call about his Communicators Hall of Fame election from U.S. Harness Writers Association president Barry Lefkowitz.

"He told me and then it started to sink in and then we started talking about hockey for two hours," said Warkentin with a laugh. "It kind of sums up your career. It kind of sums up your life. It puts a nice bow on a lot of work."

Even though they never worked together, former voice of The Meadowlands Tom Durkin had a profound influence on the announcer that Warkentin would become.

"Long ago, I tried to figure out the right way to do this and there weren't many out there that inspired me except Tom Durkin," said Warkentin.

Coincidently, the three best pieces of advice that Warkentin ever received all came from people who have at least, occasionally, handled a mic.

"Jack Stevens told me 'The stars are on the track and your job is to highlight them. That's it. You're not the star, they're the stars," said Warkentin. "Earl Lennox said 'If you want to pursue this that's up to you but you really need to try different things, different jobs.' And [Hall of Famer] Jerry Connors told me 'Talk to people. Go out and ask questions."

Warkentin was extremely close to Hall of Fame announcer Sam McKee, who died unexpectedly at 54 from stroke complications in 2017.

It's not lost on Warkentin that going into the Hall will put him back in the same room with McKee, since their sketches will hang near one another. And he believes that McKee is happy for him.

"We were a good team," said Warkentin. "Sam was the king. I try to be better every day. And I know I'm 63 and father time wins every time. But, when you're able to utilize what you're good at and you enjoy it, isn't that the key to life?

"It's got to be fun and if it's not fun, find something else. I really love the pressure. Put me in that spot. I'm prepared. I'm ready to go. Now, you can put the light on. Put me there. I want to be there. I want that pressure."

Drake made the trip to Goshen, NY when the "King of PEI", driver Wally Hennessey, was inducted and has Sunday, July 2, 2023 circled on his calendar.

"He's pretty humble," said Drake of Warkentin. "I'm not sure he realizes the connection that he has [with the fans]. He's very recognizable and very approachable and easy to talk to, so he fits right in with our Island charm here."

40 YEARS SINCE

Workaholic, the first Breeders Crown winner, was born 40 years ago (3/15/82). We are about two weeks from his milestone win in the first ever Breeders Crown, held at Lexington on Oct. 5, 1984. His yearling ad looked like this:

"Half brother to European champion At Risk 3, 1:59.4, the first 3-year-old to trot under 2:00 in Europe and winner of his first 17 starts. Family of Speedy Somolli world champion 1:55."

Hip #68 Bertie Schuyler: "Buyer bought more horse then he can handle."

Yes, there was another trotting filly named Atlanta. She was born in 1883 and was sired by Attorney.

Several ownership transfers and she wound up the property of Daniel Hayes. Her first foal in 1888 was Alix, who became the fastest ever female trotter $-2.03 \, \frac{3}{4}$.

Her second dam was sired by the thoroughbred lowa.

60 YEARS AGO YOU SAY?

In 1962, \$928,740,959 was bet on the sport up 8.2 per cent from 1961. The attendance of 16,161,655 was up 6 per cent from the year prior.

Su Mac Lad was 8-for-13 and earned Horse of the Year honors.

There were 112 2:00 miles recorded 94 by pacers and 18 by trotters.

Matastar twice time trialed in 1:55.4 in an attempt to lower Greyhound's record set 24 years earlier.

A Cs Viking won the Hambletonian for Sanders Russell who with a broken ankle had to be lifted in and out of the race bike.

JIM CAMPBELL

If he makes it to the 2023 Hambletonian at age 61, it would be the same age as his brother John when he made his final Hambletonian start (2016 – ninth with The Royal Harry).

Jim is a one-time assistant to Glen Garnsey — but only after he assisted John in 1982 the year they won the Jug with Merger.

Run The Table, Tagliabue, Indian Alert, Jefs Eternity — it's easy to forget some of Jim Campbell's former stars because he is still so relevant.

Still, MacDonald is a long way from his \$300 first purchase of Jim Bob Skipper at age 13. His first two winners on the fair circuit at the very same oval Joe O'Brien won his first races in 1932 — St. Peters Matinee Track.

Sparkling race card at Solvalla on Saturday

Three-year-old trotters are in focus when the \$800,000 Kriteriet and 560,000 Oaks are on the race card at Solvalla on Saturday (Sept. 24). In addition to the two big stakes races, a \$150,000 STL open is on the menu.

Roger Walmann-trained Bedazzled Sox (Brillantissime) will most likely be the bettors' choice in Kriteriet over 2,640 meters. Walmann's horse won his elimination heat at Solvalla on Sept. 9 without problem after a front-end trip. Bedazzled Sox won the \$200,000 E3 in July, finished second in the \$200,000 E3 in August and is by far the most merited trotter in the field Saturday. In his runner up performance in E3, Stefan Melander's Nuncio son Following proved to be the best. Paired with Björn Goop, Following will be a serious shot in Kriteriet.

Walmann trains three contenders, Daniel Redén has four horses in the race, of which three of them won their respective eliminations. Redén's main driver, Örjan Kihlström, drove all four horses in the eliminations and he has opted for the only one that didn't win for the final. Kihlström's choice is Xanthis Harvey (Propulsion), who starts from post 11.

In the \$560,000 Oaks, Timo Nurmos has pole position with three horses in the race, where Aurelia Express (Readly Express) and Bonnewille W.I. (S.J.'s Caviar) start from the best positions, post 1 and 2 over 2,140 meters.



Cinema standardbred: a plot to promote the sport of harness racing - Part 5

Alternative Actions (AA) continues its series developed to offer the solution that has the best chance to change the nature of the film industry's ambivalence towards harness racing and perhaps inspire someone to pioneer a project that could be the most successful promotional tool standardbred racing ever utilized.

Year after year movies are released. Audiences and critics praise many of them and hand out award after award. Make no mistake about one thing, though. A movie is a community project. A veritable city neighborhood filled with residents have their creative and technical hands in it, all under the supervision of the Big Dog — the director. Yet, every movie begins with one or two writers describing a movie, i.e., a script.

The journey of script-to-film is long and arduous, but scriptwriters have total control and freedom before the work is put through the community-art mill. Even so, screen writers, especially newcomers, are inundated before writing a word. The good news is they do not have to be stunned before starting because there is a free writing tool offering countless ideas for stories (from start to finish) and it is free.

This is not a scam; this is a gift to be used that is accepted by the community of art. It is a library of well-constructed characters and stories used over and over — because they work. The proof is in hundreds of scripts made into movies. I offer proof blatantly, shamelessly, gratis adaptations.

You may not have struggled through Homer's 15th century epic poem "The Odyssey" but enjoyed the 2000 film, "O Brother Where Art Thou?" The Coen brothers turned the plot about Greek hero Odysseus' journey home war into a satire about three convicts escaping prison to search for treasure.

Re-imagining classic plots without being accused of plagiarism

is common using classic literature. A wealth of film scripts are smeared with Shakespearean literary plots, themes, premises and even dialogue. "Motocrossed" (2001) is "Twelfth Night." "10 Things I Hate About You" (1999) used "Taming Of The Shrew" and Cole Porter's "Kiss Me Kate" was a Broadway musical about "Shrew" that became a musical film. Disney's 1994 animated hit, "Lion King" took generously from "Hamlet" and "West Side Story" is an adaptive "Romeo & Juliet."

Steve Martin's 1987 "Roxanne" was a contemporary version of Edmond Rostund's 1897 "Cyrano de Bergerac." Broadway's "Man of La Mancha" was book one of Miguel de Cervantes' 17th-century novel "Don Quixote." And on and on.

Some movies have strong similarities to other movies, thanks to inspiration, which rarely is indicted for copyright infringement. The original "The Magnificent Seven" is a cultural spin on Akira Kurosawa's "Seven Samurai." The 1981 space thriller "Outland" owes its story structure to 1952's "High Noon," and the original "Alien" is a glossy rendering of 1958's "It! The Terror From Beyond Space."

There are countless others but I rest my case. If you look into it, the volume of free and available adaptations is vast; it is a library abundant with the basic tools any screen writer needs to dismiss all excuses for not starting to write a screenplay or, for the matter of this series, not using harness racing as the "atmosphere" to support a proven-to-work premise from another literary source. I say proven because though the foundations of any screenplay are finite, they still allow great freedoms to be creative.

It is time to lay the groundwork. I am going to explain my process; show you how best to re-imagine a classic literary piece delivering elements needed to write your screenplay with a harness-racing presence. Purely for use in this exercise, I will choose the classic piece and its premise (thematic truth) and follow through with the process.

To show the process durable, start by choosing a genre. That's right, it's your choice. Do you want the screenplay to be science fiction, comedy, horror? Choose carefully because you will have to be loyal to the genre. I am going to use drama in modern times.

My classic-literature model is Mary Shelley's gothic novel, "Frankenstein."

The novel itself is based upon another classic source — the Greek myth of Prometheus, a human who steals fire from the gods to become god-like. There are a number of premises to work with when re-imagining. The source is a guide.

My re-imagining will be driven by the premise: "Vanity leads to self-destruction." I need not be concerned about a title or a specific location where the characters develop. I am merely a servant of the premise. Every scene in my screenplay has one purpose--move the story along and nurture the development of the characters so the completed script proves the premise.

The process ensues in the next part of the series.

Kildare King targets a crown at Harrah's Hoosier Park

Kildare King may not hold the star status several of his rivals possess in the fifth edition of the \$220,000 Caesar's Trotting Classic tonight (Sept. 23) at Harrah's Hoosier Park, but one thing is certain: it will be all systems go for the gelding to take center stage.

"He has an engine on him," said trainer Chris Beaver. "He can really trot all day long and he deserves the opportunity."

Assigned post position nine in a field of 10, Kildare King, will have leading dash-winning driver Aaron Merriman holding the lines. The duo is 10-1 on the morning line and must face Cuatro De Julio (post position one, Yannick Gingras, 2-1), 2019 Hambletonian victor Forbidden Trade (post position six, Bob McClure, 6-1) and Breeders Crown winner Jujubee (post position seven, Andrew McCarthy, 5-1).

There is also the champion mare Bella Bellini (post position 10, Dexter Dun, 7-2).

Kildare King, however, will make the most of his spot behind the starter. Especially since he established a new track standard of 1:51.4 in his last performance at El Dorado Scioto Downs on Sept. 10.

Kildare King was placed in the New Jersey and Kentucky Sire Stakes programs as 3-year-old where he never quite put it all together.

As a freshman and sophomore Kildare King compiled a record of 22-2-3-2-2 and banked \$68,475. But as a 4-year-old the gelding has blossomed.

Kildare King has been victorious in 10 of his 15 trips to the post his season with one second and one third. He has earned \$226,730 and won six of his last 10 races.

"He really is a nice horse and is very competitive," Beaver said. "He earned his chance to show he belongs."

The gelding competes for his breeder, Robert Goodman.

Beaver also harnesses Ohio champion Winning Ticket (post position five, driver Todd McCarthy, 20-1). The 4-year-old son of Triumphant Caviar-Lotto Winner has not visited the winner's circle this season in two starts but his only loss last season from 12 pari-mutuel starts was a third in the \$479,135 Canadian Trotting Classic.

Winning Ticket has banked \$517,260 with a record of 22-15-0-1 for his trainer, Steven Zeehandelar, Tim Homan and Jim Burnett.

The Caesar's Trotting Classic is a component of an outstanding 15-race card at Hoosier Park that includes Bulldog Hanover, the world's fastest Standardbred, in the Hoosier Park Pacing Derby, Hambletonian winner Cool Papa Bell in the \$90,000 Phil Langley Memorial and Hambletonian Oaks winner Fashion Schooner in the \$110,000 Moni Maker.

Shenandoah Downs' seventh harness season kicked off with solid racing, ADW streaming

Shenandoah Downs kicked off a new era of racing in Woodstock, VA this past weekend, video streaming its racing feed to major Advance Deposit Wagering outlets for the first time ever. Race fans that have accounts with TVG, Xpressbet, Twinspires and NYRAbets were able to wager all the weekend action in Virginia's Shenandoah Valley, and will be able to throughout the eightweek meet which continues through Nov. 6.

The track opened last Friday (Sept. 16) with an eight-race card and followed Saturday with an 11-race program which featured a \$10,000 open trot and three consecutive pacing events which finished in 1:55 or faster.

Fans, on track and online, saw Todd Warren guide 9-year-old Muscle Hill gelding Jack Verno — a trotter he co-owns with Lester Peters and Richard Tomei — take over the lead from Creekside Pete at the half in the feature, then maintain a 1 ¾-length cushion all the way to the finish. Jack Vernon crossed in 1:57.1 and won for the seventh time this year.

The first of those three consecutive paces kicked off when track record holder John's Dream initially won an \$8,000 conditioned pace in 1:54.3, but the 9-year-old Dream Away gelding was placed second for causing interference to runner-up Art Nukem, who was awarded the victory in 1:55. The winner is driven/owned by Corey Braden and trained by Stacey McLenaghan.

Archie Buford piloted Benjamin Patrick's Crius n Rock to a win next in a \$5,250 conditioned pace in 1:54.4. The 6-year-old Rock n Roll Heaven gelding won earlier this year in 1:54 at Oak Grove. Buford is competing at Shenandoah for the first time ever. The 35-year-old driver/trainer scored earlier in Saturday's card with Ideal Big Guy.

The third speedy mile was authored by reinsman Fern Paquet Jr. in a \$7,000 conditioned pace aboard William Dagget Jr. and Lawrence Vukovich's McNeil Z Tam in 1:54.2. The 5-year-old son of Sweet Lou, who triggered a 1:51.4 effort at Pocono last year, won for the first time this year for trainer Jennifer Sansone.

Shenandoah Downs kicks off its second week of fall racing with a 10-race card on today (Sept. 23) at 4 p.m. Happy hour specials include \$2 draft beers and \$1 hot dogs. Saturday's card starts at 1 p.m. and the first 400 fans receive a free commemorative baseball cap.
