Greenshoe's origin story goes back two decades for Katz and Libfeld

Well ensconced as top owners, Marvin Katz and Al Libfeld are now making their mark as breeders of outstanding trotters such as All The Time, Ariana G and now Greenshoe.

Less than a year and a half after Torontonians Marvin Katz and Al Libfeld won the 1997 Meadowlands Pace as part-owners of Dream Away (with Sam Goldband), another momentous harness racing moment occurred for them at the Standardbred Horse Sales Company's yearling auction in Harrisburg, PA. On Nov. 3, 1998, late pedigree guru Bart Glass bought a Balanced Image filly named Soulful Hanover for \$50,000 on behalf of Katz and Libfeld.

"The family is what we call a classic, old Hanover family," Katz said.

More than 20 years later, that purchase has paid off in an incredible specimen named Greenshoe that is the pinnacle of the Libfeld-Katz Breeding Partnership. Soulful Hanover not only earned over \$430,000 on the track, more importantly, she is Greenshoe's great granddam.

Soulful Hanover only had five foals before foundering and dying in 2009, but her first foal, a Yankee Glide filly named Sheer Soul, would go on to produce the Donato Hanover mare Designed To Be in 2011. Designed To Be finished second to Lifetime Pursuit in the 2014 Hambletonian Oaks and earned more than \$650,000 before hitting the breeding shed herself.

"That was the year that Father Patrick was being bred on a limited breeding in New Jersey and we were part-owners of Father Patrick as well, so Perry Soderberg recommended the mating as a very attractive one and we bred her to Father Patrick that year he was in New Jersey and that was her first foal," Katz said of a colt born in 2016 that Libfeld originally named Rifleman after The Rifleman, one of the 1950s westerns he loved watching on TV as a kid.

"He was an outstanding individual from the time he was born," Katz said. "He was at the head of his class as he was growing up and the market clearly identified the individuality and that he had great athletic ability and pedigree and a dam that was a champion mother. He had the whole package. As someone who appreciates the greatness in the sport, he was a clear example of breeding the best to the best and hoping for the best.

"Like all of our colts, he was foaled at Kentuckiana Farm. In the fall of his weanling year he was sent over to the Glass farm and raised under Bobby Brady's supervision with Jimmy Glass at the Glass farm and then was returned to Kentuckiana in the fall to be prepared for the fall sales."

Rifleman sold for \$330,000 to Sweden's Courant, Inc. on Oct. 3, 2017 at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale. He was purchased two days after the infamous Las Vegas shooting in which 58 people were killed, so Courant's Anders Strom

thought a name change would be prudent. In keeping with his tradition of giving all his yearlings born in the same year names that start with the same first letter, Strom picked the "G" name Greenshoe after the financial term "Greenshoe Option" which is the potential extra shares sold if a successful share issue (IPO) is oversubscribed.

Greenshoe, which Courant now co-owns with Swedes Hans Backe and Lars Granqvist and Norwegian Morten Langli, is scheduled to race Sunday at Lexington's Red Mile, one of a handful of final races before the Marcus Melander trainee becomes a stallion at Hanover Shoe Farms.

Blessed with incredible speed and power, Greenshoe has earned nearly \$970,000 on the track, is currently ranked second in the weekly Hambletonian Society / Breeders Crown poll, sports a record of 10-2-0 in 14 career starts, a mark of 1:50.1 and is expected to try to lower that mark significantly in Lexington, all in a bid to further his legacy.

"To have a horse that even gets into the conversation with the types of things that are being said about him, he has to be incredibly exceptional and I think clearly he's demonstrated that he's capable of doing things that very few horses have ever been capable of doing," Katz said. "The question is how far will he go? That remains to be seen, of course. You always need good luck and good fortune and everything to come together for you, but I don't think anybody questions that this is a very rare trotter and one of the best we may have ever seen."

For Katz and Libfeld specifically, Greenshoe represents what they started out wanting to accomplish as commercial breeders — produce some of the greatest standardbreds of all time.

"Greenshoe is really the first at the leading edge of a Libfeld-Katz product. We bred the mother, the granddam and we acquired the great granddam, so this is clearly the program we always envisioned developing many years ago and it's really beginning to bear fruit and reward," Katz said, adding that superstar sisters and back-to-back Hambletonian Oaks winners All The Time and Ariana G, that he and Libfeld also produced, are also examples of the breeders' considerable effort and investment coming to fruition.

"Our breeding program continues to develop to be one of the preeminent breeding programs in the business and that was the objective. We wanted to create broodmares and produce great champions and to be able to watch a horse that you bred win a Hambletonian Oaks, that is an exhilarating, exciting feeling... a feeling of satisfaction and

Greenshoe's full-brother, Maverick, is set to sell as hip #44 on Oct. 1, the opening night of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale. There is also a weanling half-brother, sired by Muscle Hill, named Bonanza, on the ground.

Katz said he's looking forward to seeing Maverick sell, but he's perhaps more excited about the Libfeld-Katz Breeding Partnership being the corporate sponsor of this year's Breeders Crown at Woodbine Mohawk Park and especially the Breeders Crown Charity Challenge that will include an auction on Oct. 2 at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale of breedings to some of the sport's top stallions (full story here).



Farewell, Hanover, you will be missed

Please forgive me as I digress from a mostly harness racing column to a mostly personal one.

As of Sept. 14, 2019, I am no longer a resident of Hanover, PA.

I and my family have lived in this lovely borough since March 15, 1966. It is a place that has been ultra-kind to me and my family — one for which I feel nothing but gratitude and to which I owe a large personal debt.

My three children were born and raised here, as were two of my five grandchildren. My three California grandkids have also spent many fruitful hours there. I am sure they regard it as their second home.

When we first arrived, my late wife Marlene went kicking and screaming.

There was no way that she wanted to move from metropolitan and soigne Montreal to what she then regarded as a "hick town" with less than 15,000 residents.

She realized that not only would it become the place where her husband would make his living, but that it would also be a fulfillment of a lifetime dream for him.

She was prepared, but not all that happy to leave her family and friends in Montreal to a new environment where she knew no one.

Eventually, of the two of us, she grew to love Hanover and life in Hanover more than even I.

I was the lucky one. I was fulfilling a lifetime dream indulging in my passion, harness racing, and getting paid to do it — perhaps most importantly, in the area of it that most interested me, the breeding of the horses that make the industry run.

In addition, I was lucky in not only living in a wonderful place, but I also was to gain the freedom of mixing life living on and later near the world's greatest breeding farm with the

ability to travel to racetracks throughout the world and meet and interact with hundreds and perhaps thousands of harness racing devotees throughout a 52 plus year period. It was truly a dream come true.

I lived that dream for decades.

I was so fortunate to meet so many great people, both in and out of the industry. I made several friends with whom I shared a lifetime.

All was not wine and roses though.

I lost Marlene to that horrible addiction called tobacco, just a few months short of our 40th anniversary. Damned cigarettes!


But I was also so very lucky to hit the jackpot a second time when I met my lovely life partner Sweet Carol Stein, less than two years after the loss of Marlene.

We have now been together almost 14 years.

Up to this point it has been a rather unusual relationship.

There was no way she would, at that stage in her life, even consider moving to a rural environment.

Saturday morning at "The Deck" from January through March is usually the highlight of my week.

Carol and I both retired this year and we made the life altering decision to buy a home in Florida and live there for the majority of the year. Tentatively, we would like to rent something furnished in the New York metropolitan area and live there up to three months during the summer.

The main reason for this change is that New York is just too darned expensive for people living on a fixed income. It costs me \$55 dollars a night just to park my car.

New York is just not my bag of tea for permanent residence. I like all that the city has to offer. But I cannot imagine myself living here for an entire week or two, let alone in any state of permanence.

I would be totally remiss if I didn't thank those who have made my Hanover life so wonderful through the years.

They include, but are not necessarily limited to, Dr A W Patterson Jr, who made life so acceptable to some newbies coming to live in a community so different than that from which we were used to, Lawrence Sheppard who gave this kid a chance, Artie Silverman, who I suspect pulled a few strings behind the scenes, John Simpson Sr who was a surrogate father and a great teacher. Life wasn't always easy with him, but what you saw was what you got. The good was far, far better than any possible bad. Dr Peter Boyce, a good friend and a terrific horseman, Dr Bridgette Jablonsky, the same as Peter and in my opinion the best farm manager around today, Dr Garner Greenhoff, a great veterinarian, Paul E Spears, a man who trusted me to do my job, but woe was me if and when I screwed up, Eddie Miller one of the best horsemen I've ever known, Ralph Lemmon, a dear friend and a genuinely good guy who was the best at what he did, Dale Welk, a terrific quy, who does a great job with every job entrusted to him; also some terrific friends like Moe Graif, Fred Grant, Geoff Stein, David Reid, Bob Boni, Myron Bell, Frank "The Elder" Antonacci and many others too numerous to mention.

I've been truly blessed.

Buckeye Classic Yearling Sale average on par with 2018 sale

The fifth edition of the Buckeye Classic Yearling Sale took place Tuesday (Sept. 24) at the Champions Center Expo in Springfield, OH. A catalog of 207 yearlings were consigned to the sale, conducted by Hoosier Classic Sale Company LLC, with 196 passing through the sale ring during the course of the day. That group combined to sell for a gross of \$1.65 million, good for an average of \$8,435. Last year's Buckeye Classic saw 184 babies gross \$1.54 million and average \$8,409.

"I'm pleased with the sale," said sale manager Steve Cross. "We sold 12 more yearlings than in 2018 and the sale average remained relatively unchanged. I was very encouraged by the number of first time buyers that came out and bought yearlings. There were a lot of new faces and new buyers."

All told, seven yearlings brought \$20,000 or more, with the session topped by Forged Steel, cataloged as Hip 91, and bringing a final bid of \$29,000. The bay colt is the first foal out of Ohio Breeders Championship final winner Bell Flower, p,4, 1:52.4f (\$251,509). Consigned by Abby Stables, Forged Steel is from the first crop of Bettors Delight stallion and millionaire Domethatagain. Ryan Miller of Greenville, OH signed the ticket as agent.

A trio of yearlings in the Abby Stables consignment brought \$20,000 or more. Fanciful Invention, a Triumphant Caviar filly out of Merrie Anabelle final winner Reinvent, was hammered down for \$25,000. The yearling is a half-sister to Refined, who earned just over \$100,000 since the filly was cataloged as Hip 24. Chris Beaver signed the slip. Hip 138, Filly Named Pete, brought \$20,000, purchased by agent Danny Collins. The Uncle Peter yearling is out of Escadilla, a mare that has produced four winners from five foals.

"I'm very satisfied with the sale," said Marion "Beach" Beachy of Abby Stables. "It was great to have the sale topper. It was the first crop of Domethatagain selling. The sale probably exceeded my expectations. I was hoping to average between \$10,000 and \$12,000 and I think we did that."

Abby Stables sold 18 yearlings for \$226,200, signaling an average of \$12,567.

Uncle Peter colt Peters Royalty brought the second highest bid at the Buckeye Classic, selling for \$28,000. Consigned by Winterwood Farm, acting as agent for March Valley

Forged Steel, a son of Domethatagain out of Ohio Breeders Championship final winner Bell Flower, topped Tuesday's Buckeye Classic Yearling Sale with a bid of \$29,000 from Ryan Miller, agent, of Greenville, OH.

Standardbreds, Hip 131 is out of Yankee Glide mare Dream Of Royalty, a half-sister to Soulful Delight 2, 1:57, 3, 1:55.1f (\$452,688) and Like A Dream 4, 1:56 (\$270,722). Bobby Brower signed the ticket on the colt.

Winterwood Farm led all consignments in average, with 10 yearlings bringing \$147,000 total. Hip 79, Countess Kate, led the farm's non-agent horses, garnering a \$20,000 final bid from Millersburg, OH resident Marty Miller. The Full Count filly possess a pedigree filled with black type winners, and is a full sister to \$260,000 winner Anastasia Whinnie. The Bellville, OH breeding operation also sold Dejarmbro filly SSS Mindee, the first foal from a full sister to \$300,000 winner Atlas Peak, for \$19,000.

Two Shades Of Brown, a Mr Wiggles filly consigned by Clearview Stables, turned out to be the second-highest pacing yearling sold during the Tuesday session. She is out of Somebeachsomewhere mare Sneacret Hanover, half-sister to Breeders Crown elimination winner Sutter Hanover p,3, 1:50.1s (\$885,689). Kirk Nichols of London, Ohio, bid \$19,000 for the bay, cataloged as Hip 36.

Ohioan Chris Beaver was the most active buyer at the sale, signing tickets on seven yearlings and spending \$106,000. Besides Fanciful Invention, Beaver purchased three other babies sired by Triumphant Caviar. 

Illinois 2020 dates awarded

Following a week of uncertainty, the Illinois Racing Board on Tuesday approved the 2020 dates applications of Arlington International Racecourse, Hawthorne Race Course and the proposed new harness track in south suburban Chicago.

Racing exclusively on weekend nights, Hawthorne will conduct 90 harness racing programs from Feb. 15 through Sept. 20.

Hawthorne President Tim Carey decided not to hold the track's traditional spring thoroughbred meeting next year in order to accelerate the daytime construction of its casino that he hopes to open during the 37-program fall thoroughbred meeting, running from Oct. 2 through Nov. 28.

The new Playing in the Park, LLC. harness track/casino that Rick Heidner is planning to build in south suburban Tinley Park was awarded a 12-night inaugural meeting from Dec. 6-29 with racing on Sundays, Mondays and Tuesdays. Carey is partnering with Heidner in the venture.

Arlington was awarded 68 days of thoroughbred racing from April 27 through Sept. 30.

Much to the consternation of thoroughbred horsemen and the Racing Board, Arlington has declined to apply for the casino license that it is entitled to under the massive Illinois gambling expansion bill that was passed during the spring session of the legislature and signed into law by Gov. J.B. Pritzger in June.

That controversial decision put Arlington and its parent company, Churchill Downs, Inc. (CDI), on the firing line the previous week when the dates hearings began.

Adding to what Racing Board chairman Jeff Brincat called "the controversy and chaos" was an August statement that coincided with the rejection of a casino at the track in which CDI Chief Executive Officer Bill Carstanjen said the corporation is committed to conducting meetings at Arlington in 2020 and 2021 but beyond that left the future of the track shrouded in uncertainty.

No representatives of CDI were present at the Sept. 17 hearings and Arlington president Tony Petrillo didn't have the answers to the hard questions hurled at him by Brincat and board member Tom McCauley.



The board recessed the hearings until Tuesday and demanded that a CDI representative be present to testify.

The delay fueled speculation that the board might deny Arlington 2020 dates, thereby necessitating major changes in the harness and thoroughbred schedules that Hawthorne had applied for and disrupting the plans of horsemen of both breeds.

Consensus among racing insiders is that CDI's stated claim that it is not pursuing the gaming license that Arlington had sought for decades is because taxes on it to fund purses are "financially untenable" is bogus and the real reason is to protect another of its holdings from competition. Late last year CDI spent \$326 million to obtain a 62 per cent share in Rivers Casino, which is only 14 miles from Arlington and is the most profitable of the state's existing casinos.

Brad Blackwell, CDI senior vice-president and general counsel, came to Tuesday's meeting and was interrogated at length by McCauley. But Blackwell said what McCauley wanted to know was confidential corporate information.

"We cannot discuss any of these things," he replied when asked if CDI had made a non-compete agreement involving Arlington when it purchased its share in Rivers, if CDI had meetings to discuss selling Arlington or meetings to discuss selling the track property as real estate.

With regard to the decision not to apply for a gaming license, he said: "We don't have all the answers now. What we're doing is trying to find the answers. We need time to figure this out.

"We hope the gaming bill works for Hawthorne, Fairmount Park and Rick Heidner. This is the fifth year of a joint agreement that we have with Hawthorne on dark times (revenue) and dates and it was signed on July 30 — after the signing of the gaming bill."

The gambling expansion legislation won't take effect until Jan. 1 so revenue from the casinos at Hawthorne, the new track in Tinley Park and the downstate thoroughbred track Fairmount won't bolster their purse accounts until 2021.

That fact prompted the decision of the board to rubber stamp the 2020 schedule requested under the joint agreement between Hawthorne and Arlington.

"The agreement between the parties should have a lot of

weight for 2020," McCauley said. "There would be so much disruption for people's lives if this schedule changed.

"Am I happy there are not casinos at Arlington? Of course not. Is that what the legislature intended (for there to be casinos at Arlington)? Yes, it is."

In complete contrast to Arlington, with regard to casinos Hawthorne is hot to trot. Carey applied for a license on Aug. 26, the first day for applications to be submitted.

"We've been waiting 15 years for this opportunity," he told the Racing Board. "That is what it is all about. This is why we hung in there as long as we did.

"It will be a \$450 million development. We hope to obtain approval by Dec. 26 and start construction the first part of January. The casino will be on the second floor and will occupy 4,000 square feet.

"We hope to complete the complex by Nov. 1 (2020). No way we could do that with a spring thoroughbred meeting. They don't race at night like the harness horses do. And the harness horses don't spook like the thoroughbreds do (during training on the track).

"Running these dates is a one-time deal. We'll go back to a spring thoroughbred meeting in 2021. We will do whatever it takes for both breeds to gain by what we do. We hope to have a great 2020 fall thoroughbred meet coinciding with the opening of the casino."

Bob Molaro, the former state senator and state representative who is employed by Hawthorne as a consultant, is just as enthusiastic.

"Tim is making sure that it's a racetrack that has a casino, not a casino that has a racetrack," he said. "This will kick start the south suburbs — there will be twice the number of jobs; twice the economic opportunity."

Of the adjusted gross revenue at the racetrack casinos 12.75 per cent will go to purses.

"We support the Illinois Harness Horsemen's Association, Hawthorne and Rick Heidner," Illinois Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association President Mike Campbell said, giving his organization's blessing to the 2020 schedule. "The focus should be on Hawthorne. They're willing to put up hundreds of millions of dollars."

A sloppy night of champions at Hawthorne

After a string of weeks of gorgeous weather at Hawthorne Race Course, Mother Nature wasn't nearly as kind when it came to Saturday's Night of Champions for Illinois breds on Sept. 21. The 12-race card kicked off with a fast track, but the skies opened up prior to the start of the 11 stakes events, leaving for sloppy going through the stakes action.

THE ROBERT S MOLARO CHAMPIONSHIP

Jim Ballinger's **Fox Valley Gemini**, two-time Illinois Horse of the Year, went off as the 1-5 favorite in the \$45,000 Robert S. Molaro and didn't disappoint. Winning his fourth straight race, Fox Valley Gemini drew off to a commanding victory, getting the mile in a lifetime best of 1:50. At the finish, he was seven and a half lengths clear of the rest of the field. Dakota Roadster got up for second while Royale Rose got third.

Driven by Casey Leonard and trained by Terry Leonard, Fox Valley Gemini won for the 30th time from only 39 starts.

As written above, Fox Valley Gemini got the mile in 1:50 after fractions of :27.1, :59, and 1:22.3.

THE FOX VALLEY FLAN CHAMPIONSHIP

Lous Abigail, winning for the seventh time in 10 starts, took Saturday's \$82,000 Fox Valley Flan Championship, for three years old and up Illinois-bred pacers. Driven by leading driver Casey Leonard and trained by Steven Searle, Lous Abigail won by a comfortable four and three-quarter lengths. Owned by Flacco Family Farms LLC, Lous Abigail got the mile in 2:00.1, after fractions of :29.4, :58.4 and 1:28.3.

Bee See held on for second while Fox Valley Lush finished third.

THE INCREDIBLE TILLIE CHAMPIONSHIP

Morning-line favorite but second-choice in the wagering, **Fox Valley Exploit**, owned by David Brigham and Kyle Husted, and driven and trained by Kyle Husted, won the \$115,000 Incredible Tillie Championship, for two-year-old filly trotters, by three and a half lengths. They raced through fractions of :29.4, :58.4, 1:28.3 with a final time of 2:00.1

THE PLESAC CHAMPIONSHIP

It was never really a contest. Danny S. Graham's **Annas Lucky Star,** already a track-record holder, simply dominated in Saturday's \$45,000 Plesac Championship, for 3-year-olds and up ICF trotters. She took the lead quickly and won as she pleased, going off at 1-9 and drawing off to win by 15 lengths. Her time of 1:56.3 was seconds slower than her lifetime best of 1:53.1 but it didn't matter. She set modest fractions of :30, :59, and 1:27.3.

Trained by Nelson Willis and driven by Kyle Wilfong, Annas Lucky Star won for the 33rd time in her career, and her ninth from 15 starts in 2019.

Primed N Powerful tracked all the way and held for second with Majistic Caprice finishing third.

THE BEULAH DYGERT MEMORIAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Flacco Family Farms' popular filly **Louzotic** made every pole a winning one in the \$95,000 Beulah Dygert Memorial Championship, for 3-year-old ICF filly trotters, on Saturday night. Winning for the 11th time in 15 starts this year, including her fifth straight, Louzotic had regular driver Kyle Husted in the bike. This talented filly is trained by Steven Searle.

She finished six and a quarter lengths ahead of rival Heidi High with Lous Paramour getting up for the show dough.

Louzotic led all the way through fractions of :29.1, :59.4, 1:29.4 with a final time of 1:58.3.

THE ERWIN F. DYGERT CHAMPIONSHIP

Lourhianon, winning for the second straight time since getting Lasix, overcame the outside post position and the sloppy track to take the \$92,000 Erwin F. Dygert Memorial, for 3-year-old ICF colts and geldings, going away. Owned by C Lawrence Mc Burney, trained by Kennedy Lindsey, and driven by Luke Plano, Lourhianon took the lead soon after coming out of the far turn, raced wide through the stretch and still won by six and three-quarter lengths.

He got the mile in 1:57.3 after early fractions of :29.4, :59.3, and 1:29. Frontier Maynard grabbed second with For Trots Sakes coming in third.

THE KADABRA CHAMPIONSHIP

When favored Fox Valley Quest broke coming out of the first turn in Saturday's \$108,000 Kadabra Championship, for 2-year-old ICF colt and gelding trotters, that opened up the opportunity for everybody else. Ed Teefey's **Crooked Creek** took advantage. Winning for the third straight time and the fifth time in nine races, Ryan Anderson guided this Mike Brink trainee to a six-length victory in 1:55.3. Desert Sheik, another Brink-trained trotter, finished second. Longshot Fitchey For Fun snagged third place.

Early fractions for the race were :29.4, :58.1. and 1:27.3.

THE INCREDIBLE FINALE CHAMPIONSHIP

Triple Zzz's **He'zzz A Wise Guy** was a three and a quarter-length winner in Saturday's \$102,000 Incredible Finale Championship. The race was for 2-year-old ICF colt and gelding pacers. His victory was his fifth straight from only seven races. Trained by Donald Filomeno, He'zzz A Wise Guy was guided to the victory by Robert Smolin.

Favored Fox Valley Ren, who had won seven of nine races, finished second with RJ Wulfy finishing third.

He covered the mile in 1:55.0 after fractions of :28.3, :57/4 and 1:27.1

THE ROBERT F. CAREY, JR. MEMORIAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Fox Valley Triton, who was beaten as the favorite in his last leg of the Carey, made amends in the \$109,000 Robert F. Carey, Jr. Memorial Championship on Saturday night. The Carey was for 3-year-old ICF colts and gelding pacers. Owned

Fox Valley Halsey finished a neck ahead of Fox Valley Lil Kim with Fox Valley Torrid a neck behind.

THE TONY MAURELLO CHAMPIONSHIP

The \$931,500 Italian Derby for 3-year-old trotters was held in Naples on Sunday night and the race became eventful. Alessandro Gocciadoro had the favorite in Axl Rose (Love You) and the duo came to the lead at a pretty early stage when stablemate Amon You Sm, paired with Antonio Greppi, willingly let the lead over to Axl Rose.

Everything looked safe for the favorite, but a sudden break with a half mile to go in the 1.3 miles long race, spoiled Axl Rose's chances to become a champion of the 2019 Derby. Axl Rose more or less stumbled himself to a break and all of a sudden, Amon You Sm was in the lead again.

Behind the new leader, champion driver Enrico Bellei steered **Alrajah One** (Maharajah) and the duo had plenty of time to find themselves out when first over trotter Aramis Bar couldn't keep up with the pace in the last turn.

Bellei let Alrajah One attack the leader seriously at the top of the stretch and the son of Maharajah easily sprinted to safe win in mile rate 1:56.4.

Amon You Sm finished second, ahead of Antony Leone.

In the \$169,300 Gran Premio Turilli, Alessandro Gocciadoro had another chance to capture a big trophy and his weapon this time was **Vivid Wise As** (Yankee Glide), who came from an impressive win in Cagnes-sur-Mer in August, where the Yankee Glide son won a mile race in 1:50.2.

Over the distance of 1.3 miles, Vivid Wise As took a clear victory from the lead and his opponents were never close to him. The mile rate was 1:55 and Vivid Wise As is now three out of three for Gocciadoro.

The \$278,000 Oaks del Trotto for the 3-year-old mares was on the race card in Naples the same day and Walter Zanetti trained **Audrey Effe** (Up And Quick) took a solid wire to wire win in a moderate 1:58.1 mile.

This was the ninth consecutive win for Audrey Effe, who is 10 out of 12 in total in her career, so the harness racing fans in Europe will surely meet the mare in some bigger

Tough trotters ready for tough final

Two eliminations for the \$440,000 Grand Prix de l'U.E.T., The European Derby for 4-year-old colts and mares, were held at Vincennes racetrack on Tuesday afternoon.

There was \$65,000 up for grabs in the two races and it was two brilliant trotters who made their way to the final, which is set at Vermo racetrack in Helsinki, Finland on Oct. 12.

Sébastien Guarato's champion **Face Time Bourbon** (Ready Cash), paired with Björn Goop came to the lead in a half mile mark of :54.1 and the dominant 4-year-old then sprinted home in a 1:53.4 mile rate win over 1.3 miles.

In the second elimination, German bred **Mister F Daag** (Conway Hall) and Robin Bakker had everything under control from the front position and Mister F Daag posted a mile rate of 1:56.2.

Face Time Bourbon and Mister F Daag are both potentially elite horses and they will most probably face the already established top of the elite class next season.

Two more eliminations remain. The races are included in the Swedish V75 at Solvalla on Saturday afternoon. Swedish duo Campo Bahia (Muscle Hill) and Cab Lane (Muscle Hill) will try to get their spots in final and get company from Finland's Derby winner Graceful Swamp (So Perfect) and Norwegian Derby winner Max Brady (Cantab Hall).

Muscle Hustle is dead

Muscle Mass son Muscle Hustle was exported from Canada to Sweden at the end of 2016 and as a 4-year-old, trainer Robert Bergh showed that he had a new horse that could be counted on in the big races in Europe.

Muscle Hustle impressively won a heat in Åby Stora Pris as a 4-year-old and finished second to Diamanten in Sprintermästaren same year.

Trainer and owner Robert Bergh decided late this summer that Muscle Hustle would be sent back overseas, where the horse was supposed to be trained by Åke Svanstedt. But according to Robert Bergh's Twitter account, Muscle Hustle became sick during the journey to the United States and after 14 days of emergency treatment, the people connected to the horse decided to let Muscle Hustle forever sleep on Tuesday afternoon.

Muscle Hustle reached a lifetime mark of 1:52.2 and earned \$445,030.

The Meadowlands may not be able to hold a fall harness meet in 2020 and, if so, will extend its Championship Meet beyond the Hambletonian and into September.

Meadowlands statement on 2020 race dates

With the major yearling sales coming up, we felt it necessary to have those with an interest in harness racing be made aware of a few recent developments involving The Meadowlands for 2020.

On Wednesday, Sept. 18 at a meeting of the New Jersey Racing Commission, a request by The Meadowlands to eliminate Lasix for 2-year-old standardbreds racing in New Jersey for 2020 and 2021 and for the 2021 Meadowlands Pace was rejected.

This request was opposed unanimously by the board of directors of the Standardbred Breeders and Owners Association of New Jersey and by some practicing veterinarians.

It is our intention to re-submit this request within the next six to eight months once we have a better understanding of how the public is going to react to the negative press that the thoroughbred industry has recently received.

In addition, we have been officially notified by the Monmouth Park Thoroughbreds that they intend to exercise their option to convert the surface of the racetrack and race on the Meadowlands main track from Oct. 2 through Dec. 5 next fall.

While it is still possible that they will reconsider based on the costs, we must assume that there will be no live harness meet next fall at the Meadowlands. Should that occur, The Meadowlands would extend the 2020 live meet beyond Hambletonian Day, racing until mid-September.

Regarding a few of the important stakes that have historically been raced during the fall meet, our intention would be to race the Kindergarten Classic Finals and TVG Finals right after the Little Brown Jug and prior to the beginning of the Lexington meet. It is as of now unclear what will be done with the Fall Freshman Final Four stakes which have annually taken place at the end of November.

In any case, we thought it important that everyone be aware of these developments so you may plan accordingly.



Carter Pinske set for Grand Circuit training debut with Amigo Volo

After finally getting to spend an entire winter in Florida working with his family's racehorses, Carter Pinske knew it was what he wanted to do full time. So, when the season was ready to begin, Pinske followed a group of those horses to trainer Richard "Nifty" Norman's stable, where he worked as an assistant for Norman in New Jersey, Canada, and now Kentucky.

On Thursday (Sept. 26), the 24-year-old Pinske will step out for his Grand Circuit training debut in the third division of the Bluegrass Stakes for 2-year-old male trotters with Amigo Volo at Lexington's Red Mile. The gelding, who heads to the race off a second-place finish behind Real Cool Sam in the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes final, is the 3-1 second choice on the morning line behind Kentucky Sire Stakes champ Ready For Moni.

Amigo Volo is owned by Pinske Stables, headed by Pinske's father Karl and grandmother Marlys, and Florida's David J. Miller. With Pinske already in Kentucky with the horse, Norman decided it was time for him to take the reins.

"He's been real generous to let me do that," Pinkse said.
"I'm very fortunate to have these owners trust me with the horses in Florida and then be completely fine with whatever Nifty decides along with myself. They're great owners and I've been really fortunate all the way around."

Prior to this past winter, Pinske helped prepare the family's horses for racing by assisting as much as time permitted around his school schedule. Pinske graduated from college in May 2018 and was happy to get a full winter with the horses in Florida before sending them to Norman as well as trainer Julie Miller, as he had done in previous years.

"I went to Florida wanting to train horses, but I didn't know it would blossom like this," Pinske said. "This year, I sent 14 horses to Nifty and I went with them. He's just an awesome guy to learn from. He puts full trust in you and lets you take off. He's a really smart guy with a horse; he's got a really good way with a horse. Just being around him, it just kind of vibrates off him.

"I'm extremely appreciative of Nifty. It's a partnership that's not going anywhere."

Amigo Volo, by Father Patrick out of Margarita Momma, was purchased for \$42,000 at last fall's Lexington Selected Sale. He is a full brother to Reign Of Honor, who won last year's Kindergarten Classic Series championship for Norman's stable.

In August, Amigo Volo won a division of the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes in 1:54.4 at Harrah's Philadelphia, setting the world record for a 2-year-old gelding trotter on a five-eighths-mile track. Real Cool Sam, who is undefeated in eight races this year, lowered the record to 1:53.4 when he won the PASS championship at the same track.

"He went a really big mile," Pinske said about Amigo Volo's runner-up effort in the sire stakes final. "He had to do a lot of the grunt work and Real Cool Sam got a great trip. I thought we might have him there, but (Real Cool Sam) is just a game horse, a tough one to beat."

For the year, Amigo Volo has won two of six races and earned \$115,896.

"He's just an awesome horse to be around," Pinske said.
"He's a little horse, a little spitfire of a horse. I had to be real patient with him down in Florida. He always showed talent, he just lacked maturity. According to Nifty, that's about how the full brother, Reign Of Honor, was when he trained down. That's why we ended up gelding him. But he always showed talent and now has finally gotten to show it here. He's a really big-gaited horse for the size he is."

Expectations, who finished second in the Kentucky Sire Stakes final, is the 7-5 morning-line favorite in the first Bluegrass division. Capricornus, who finished second in the William Wellwood Memorial, is the 2-1 choice in the second. Both horses are from the stable of trainer Marcus Melander.

Trotting freshmen to open Red Mile Grand Circuit meet

The annual fortnight of Grand Circuit racing at Red Mile begins on Thursday (Sept. 26) with three divisions of the \$315,500 Bluegrass Stakes for 2-year-old trotting colts.

Back Of The Neck fronts a field of seven in the opening Bluegrass division. The Marcus Melander-trained son of Ready Cash exits a third-place finish in the \$277,500 William Wellwood Memorial after winning his elimination in 1:55. Mattias Melander will sit behind the winner of three races from six starts — with earnings surpassing \$80,000 — from post 5 for owners Order By Stable, Judith Taylor and Howard Taylor.

Expectations, also trained by Marcus Melander, competes against his stablemate from post 7. The Muscle Hill colt, owned by Vicky Trotting Inc., finished second in the \$250,000 Kentucky Sires Stakes final after winning in two prelims and finishing third two weeks prior in the \$324,550 Peter Haughton Memorial. Brian Sears will drive the winner of two races in seven starts and \$139,399 in earnings.

Capricornus fronts the second division of Bluegrass. Another Marcus Melander trainee, the Cantab Hall colt rolled from off cover to finish second in the William Wellwood Memorial after winning his elimination by a neck in a lifetime-best 1:55.1. Jj Racing Stable Inc. owns the winner of three races from seven starts — with \$155,458 banked — and will have Tim Tetrick in the sulky from post 2.

A winner in an elimination of the Peter Haughton Memorial, Per Engblom trainee Synergy will try to rebound from an eighth-place finish in the William Wellwood Memorial. The Father Patrick colt —owned by Brittany Farms LLC, John Fielding, Herb Liverman and David Anderson — trotted a lifetime-best 1:54.4 when winning his elimination of the Haughton but finished fifth in the final. Yannick Gingras drives the winner of three races in six starts and \$102,895.

Engblom also conditions third-division frontman Ready For Moni, who enters off 1:54.1 victory in the Kentucky Sires Stakes Final. The son of Ready Cash failed to sweep the series—making a break in the first prelim—but has won in his other four starts, earning \$161,500 for John Fielding, Lindy Farms of Connecticut, Herb Liverman and Bud Hatfield. Yannick Gingras will drive from post 6.

The nine-race program to kickoff the Grand Circuit meet also features late-closing events for 2-year-old pacing and trotting fillies. A \$3,000 division of the Billings Amateur Trot starts the card with first-race post at 1:00 p.m. (EDT).

Sunny Dee crushes OSS and Flamboro Downs record

Ontario's top 3-year-old pacing fillies waged an epic battle at Flamboro Downs on Sunday night as they wrapped up their Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Gold Series regular season in a single \$158,000 division.

Top point earners **Sunny Dee**, Boadicea and Powerful Chris lined up at Posts 2, 4 and 10 in the 10-filly field and when the gate swung away all three were mixing it up through a sharp :26.3 opening quarter. Thats Incredible took a brief turn on the lead, followed by Summer Charm, but it was Sunny Dee who clocked the first fraction. Powerful Chris followed Sunny Dee away from the gate, keeping Boadicea out three-wide through the first turn before yielding to the fan favourite.

Boadicea matched strides with Sunny Dee going by the :54 half, but driver Trevor Henry was able to regain a length advantage in the turn. Heading by the 1:22.2 three-quarters Boadicea again pressed the leader, but on the final turn Henry hit the accelerator and Sunny Dee turned for home with a clear advantage which she extended to two lengths by the 1:51.1 finish. Boadicea was an impressive second for driver Jonathan Drury and trainer Bill Budd and Summer Charm finished third for driver Jody Jamieson and trainer Dave Menary.

"I didn't really think Billy's (Budd) horse might get around the turns as good as she does on the big track. Half-mile racing's a little different than mile racing," said Henry of his race strategy. "Sunny Dee's so good gaited I knew she wouldn't have a problem.

"I tried to get away on JD (Drury) in the last turn because I knew his was struggling on the turns, so I got a few lengths on him. His horse raced well too, she was out the whole way and still was second, she's a hell of a filly too."

The 1:51.1 clocking was an Ontario Sires Stakes and Flamboro Downs track record. The previous track record of 1:52 was set by Michelles Power in 2007, while the former

Ontario Sires Stakes record of 1:52.2 was established by Chancey Lady at The Raceway at the Western Fair District in 2008.

Bob McIntosh trains Sunny Dee and the Windsor resident and his partners Al McIntosh Holdings Inc. of Leamington, ON and C S X Stables of Liberty Center, OH also bred the filly, who is a half-sister to \$1.7 million winners Somewhere in L A and L A Delight.

Henry has driven Sunny Dee in all but one of her 18 lifetime starts and the pair was also victorious in the June 1 Gold Series season opener at Woodbine Mohawk Park. The Sunshine Beach filly was second twice and third once in her other three Gold Series starts, giving her a total of 162 points and ownership of third spot in the division standings behind Boadicea and Powerful Chris. The top 10 point earners will now begin preparations for the \$225,000 Super Final at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Oct. 12.

"It's a good field of fillies. It's a pretty tight bunch, they've raced tough all summer," said Henry of the top point earners, adding that the championship will likely come down to racing luck. "It'll definitely be the best trip, I think."

The Ontario Sires Stakes program makes one more stop at Flamboro Downs before the regular season comes to a close. The Dundas half-mile will host the 2-year-old trotting fillies on Wednesday, Oct. 2 for their last Gold Series event.

Next Level Stuff, Perth Angel De Vie set life marks in Keystone Classic

Next Level Stuff and **Perth Angel De Vie** each jogged to convincing victories — and life marks — in Tuesday's \$85,900 Keystone Classic for 2-year-old filly trotters at The Meadows.

Dave Palone sent Next Level Stuff forward with a quarter-pole move, only to encounter stiff resistance from the leader, Rebecca.

"I didn't expect to have to work that hard to make it back to the front, but I did," Palone said, "She did the rest on her own. I think she'll be a sires stake filly next year."

Once she crossed over, the daughter of Sebastian K S—Nantab took complete control, drawing off late to down Miss Kendra D by 4-1/2 lengths in 1:55.2, a career best. The stubborn Rebecca finished third.

Jim Campbell trains the homebred Next Level Stuff for

Runthetable Stables.

Perth Angel De Vie hadn't seen the front in her last six outings, but in the Keystone Classic, she reached the point early with a bonus — the half in a slowish 59 worked out by driver Bryce Brocklehurst.

"A cheap half like that definitely helped," he said. "I felt pretty good about things then. As long as she felt good on the gate, I wanted her to be up close. I think that's probably it for her this year."

The daughter of Explosive Matter—Dream Angel prevailed in 1:56.4, a life mark, 3-1/2 lengths better than Cocktails N Dreams. Just For Me Nu completed the ticket.

Harold Brocklehurst conditions the winner for Double R Farms, David Obley and Richard Williams.

Live racing continues today at The Meadows, when the card features a \$90,299 Keystone Classic for 2-year-old colt and gelding trotters. First post is 1:05 PM.

Hall of Fame broodmare Stienam's Place is retired

Stienam's Place retired from racing at age 4 following a Dan Patch Award-winning career. Now, at the age of 25, she is retired again, this time following a broodmare career that landed her in the Harness Racing Hall of Fame.

Barry Guariglia, whose Green Mountain Farms shares ownership of Stienam's Place with Kentuckiana Farms, said the mare would sell her final foal during next week's opening session of the Lexington Selected Sale. Twenty-four years ago, Guariglia and his racing partners, Peter Goulazian and James Greenwald, purchased Stienam's Place under the name Tranquil Sands for \$62,000 at the Kentucky Standardbred Sale.

"She's officially retired and will stay at Kentuckiana for the rest of her life," Guariglia said about Stienam's Place, who was the sport's Dan Patch Award winning 3-year-old filly pacer in 1997 and was inducted into the Hall of Fame in 2017. "She's done well and gone a long time. It's time for her to just relax, eat some grass, and run around."

Stienam's Place was from the first crop of Artsplace and the first foal out of Stienam's Girl. Her second dam, Stienam, was a Dan Patch Award winner at age 3 in 1985.

Bruce Riegle trained Stienam's Place and Jack Moiseyev handled the driving in all but several races. For her career,

she won 18 of 31 races and earned \$1.40 million. Her top win at age 2 came in the Sweetheart; at 3, her triumphs included the Breeders Crown, Jugette, Glen Garnsey, Helen Dancer, and Matron. She won 14 of the final 15 starts of her campaign. She raced once at 4, suffered a severe bone bruise, and was retired.

As a broodmare, Stienam's Place has produced 10 horses to reach the races, totaling 108 wins and \$4.67 million in purses. First foal Donkeys Can Talk was a Kentucky Sire Stakes champion, but her greatest successes came during the second half of her career as a mom.

Filly Showherthemoney was a world-record-setting stakes-winner at age 3 whose victories included the Jugette, Nadia Lobell, Matron, Glen Garnsey and Miss New Jersey. She won 19 of 54 races and \$871,161 lifetime.

At the same time Showherthemoney was enjoying her big 3-year-old campaign in 2009, 2-year-old filly Put On A Show burst on the scene by winning seven of nine races, including the She's A Great Lady. The following season, she received the Dan Patch Award for best 3-year-old filly pacer, with wins including the Breeders Crown, Nadia Lobell, and Valley Forge. She finished her career with 31 wins in 50 starts and \$2.40 million. Two of Put On A Show's offspring have gone on to be stakes-winners, Come See The Show and Meadowlands Pace champion Best In Show.

Following Showherthemoney and Put On A Show, Stienam's Place produced three more horses to earn six figures in purses: Good Day Mate (\$597,623), Rockstar Stride (\$173,240), and The Show Returns (\$377,327).

"She's had a big impact," Guariglia said. "It took her a while to hit, but with her pedigree and performance as a racehorse, we kind of figured it was just a matter of time before she clicked. Sure enough, she did.

"As a racehorse, she was a little ornery in the stall. Bruce had to keep her with a goat (named Bunny) to keep her calmed down. It worked for her. As a broodmare, she's been a perfect lady."

Guariglia, whose top horses since Stienam's Place include Dan Patch Award-winning trotter Manchego, said he always enjoyed following the horses produced by Stienam's Place. Her final foal, a colt by Somebeachsomewhere, is named Ponzu. He is hip number 62 and will sell on Oct. 1 at the Lexington Selected Sale.

"Some people say, why did you sell Put On A Show?"
Guariglia said, adding with a laugh, "Well, first of all, if I knew she was going to make \$2.4 million, maybe I wouldn't have.
But I wish people the best luck and I want to see them do

well. People have a weird angle on that stuff; it doesn't bother me at all. I enjoy watching (her offspring). Absolutely. It's kind of neat.

"She was my first great horse. She was good on the track and great in the shed. All the way around, it was a great experience."

NJSS announces new races for 4-year-olds

The Board of Trustees of the New Jersey Sire Stakes has announced that it will institute four new races for 4-year-old trotters and pacers beginning in the spring of 2020. The new races, called the New Jersey Breeders' Maturity, will be open to all horses that were nominated as yearlings to either the New Jersey Sire Stakes Premier Division or the New Jersey Standardbred Development Fund.

It is expected that the races will be conducted at The Meadowlands in late March or early April and will consist of a preliminary leg and a final. Preliminary legs will go for \$12,500 or \$15,000 depending upon the number of entries, with the top 10 point earners advancing to the finals. All preliminary legs will be contested, regardless of the number of entries. Purses for the finals shall be tiered based upon the number of entries. If less than five horses enter the purse for the final will be \$30,000; if five to seven horses are entered the purse will be \$40,000, and if more than seven enter the purse will increase to \$50,000.

To remain eligible, a nomination fee of \$200 must be made for each horse by January 15, 2020. A \$200 starting fee will be required to enter the preliminary leg. There will be no additional starting fees for horses that qualify for the finals.

Major Bay triumphs in his Gold Series debut

Neither of the favorites in Monday night's 2-year-old trotting colt Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Gold Series divisions enjoyed their trip around Grand River Raceway, but **Major Bay** and **Threefiftytwo** thoroughly enjoyed all of the Elora oval's amenities, including the winner's circle.

In the first \$105,600 division, fans sent Horse Trader off as their top choice and the colt made an early break that left him 15 lengths behind the field as Major Bay led them to the quarter in :28. Hetalkstoangels took over command heading

by the :59.2 half and continued to set the pace by the 1:28.1 three-quarters, but driver Louis-Philippe Roy was biding his time in the pocket and once he gave Major Bay an open lane the colt reeled in the leader to claim the 1:59.2 victory. Hetalkstoangels was one and one-quarter lengths back in second and Babidibou was three lengths back in third. Horse Trader settled for fourth.

"I thought he had shot, especially with the way he raced last week (Sept. 16). He knows the half-mile so he has no problem with the half-mile, and the trip worked and everything worked out good," said trainer Ben Baillargeon, who sent the colt out from Post 7. "The one horse, he was the big favourite, he made a break too, that Horse Trader, and we ended up getting the job done."

Major Bay earned his place on the gate in Monday's Gold event with a 1:56.3 fourth-place effort in the Sept. 16 overnight event at Woodbine Mohawk Park. That outing was the colt's first for Baillargeon and his first in Ontario. Major Bay's first six starts, including three wins, came at Hippodrome Trois-Rivieres for owner-trainer Francis Richard.

"He won in 2:04 in Three Rivers, but the big track stepped him up last week," said Baillargeon. "He's a little bit left and right, he's got a little bit of a rubber-neck to him, he's in and he's out, but he's got some go. He's a very gutsy horse and he has a perfect gait, so you can't ask for anything more with him because he trots, and that's all he does, he trots."

With Monday's win Major Bay earned 50 points, but he needs a second Gold Series start to be eligible for the Oct. 12 Super Final, and Baillargeon is looking forward to racing the Amigo Hall son in the last regular season event at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Oct. 1.

"He trotted 1:56.3 his first start at Woodbine and he was kind of boxed in there. He wasn't done in 1:56.4, he was running out of room a little bit, let's put it this way," said the trainer. "I'm anxious to race him next week and see what happens."

In his first seven starts Major Bay had banked \$12,525 for owners Ferme Auclair of St. Antoine De Tilly, Ecurie Francis Richard Inc. of Becancour and Jean-Christophe Auclair of Saint-Apollinaire, QC. Monday's win boosted that total to \$65,325.

After the pleasant surprise of Major Bay's victory,
Baillargeon and Roy were looking for the sweep with second
division favourite HP Royal Theo, but the reigning William
Wellwood Memorial champion skipped off-stride heading
into the first turn and was 24 lengths behind pacesetter
Threefiftytwo when he reached the :29.1 quarter. After his

successful start from Post 6, Threefiftytwo carried on through a :59.2 half and 1:29.2 three-quarters and held off Your Still Up in the stretch for a three-quarter length victory in 1:59.2. Tuckers Out was well back in third and HP Royal Theo further behind in fifth.

"I was a little worried that Louis (Roy) would try and re-take the lead, and I was worried about it because I knew full well I wouldn't be able to let him go, because mine, once he gets the front it's there's not much letting people go. He's not quite that manageable yet," said driver Bob McClure, who was quite happy Roy and HP Royal Theo never reached his wheel. "He's a really fast horse, but we're just trying to keep him well-mannered because he's pretty high strung."

McClure steers Threefiftytwo for trainer Luc Blais of Campbellville, ON and owner Determination of Montreal, QC. Monday's win was the Royalty For Life son's second in Gold Series action and his 130 points vaulted him over stablemate Port Perry to the top of the division standings heading into the regular season finale. The long-legged Port Perry skipped Monday's event.

The win was also Threefiftytwo's second straight — following a 1:55.4 personal best effort in the Sept. 16 race where Major Bay finished third — and McClure is hoping the speedy youngster can maintain his positive momentum through the last regular season Gold event and the Super Final.

"When he's on his game he can go some real wicked fast miles, it's just keeping his head on straight," said McClure. "His problem is not his gait, when he runs he gets throwing his head around, but once he's off and trotting, he's perfect, he's one of the best gaited horses. You couldn't ask him to be any better gaited, like he's almost flawless."

Monday's event wrapped up Grand River Raceway's 2019 Ontario Sires Stakes schedule, which saw the Elora oval host four Gold and four Grassroots events.

Two \$20,000 2-year-old finals held at Plainridge

The \$20,000 Wood End Light trot and \$20,000 Nauset Light pace finals, both for 2-year-old starters, were held at Plainridge Park on Monday afternoon (Sept. 23) and both winners were Massachusetts-bred horses.

In the Wood End Light, **Life Is A Feast** (Royalty For Life—Luau Hanover) went off the prohibitive favorite and didn't let his backers down. Driver Howard Parker cut

fractions of :28.1, :58.2 and 1:27 with a gapped two-length advantage going into the last turn. Life Is A Feast hit the top of the stretch all alone and trotted home a wrapped-up 3-1/2 length winner in 1:56.3.

The time was a new lifetime mark for the winner and also tied the track record for 2-year-old trotting geldings set by Hashtagmadeyalook (also bred in Massachusetts) in 2017.

It was the second straight win for Life Is A Feast (\$3.00) and owners Al Ross and Paul Fontaine. Karen Carroll bred the winner.

Later in the Nauset Light another Mass-bred, **Han Solo** (Mister Big—Leah) scored his third win in a row after leading the whole race by a length while stopping the timer in :27.1, :57.4 and 1:25.4. Around the last turn and into the stretch driver Kevin Switzer Jr. sat confidently in the bike as Han Solo paced sharply and hit the wire on top by 1-1/4 lengths in 1:55.4.

Han Solo (\$4.00), who set the track record of 1:54.1 for 2-year-old pacing colts two weeks ago, is owned by Monique Cohen who also bred and trains the horse.

Life Is A Feast and Han Solo should be considered early favorites in their prospective divisions of the \$1.8 million Massachusetts Sire Stakes which get under way this Sunday afternoon (Sept. 29) at Plainridge Park.

Legendary Canadian race-caller Frank Salive at Batavia Friday

One of the most recognizable voices in the sport of harness racing in North America is that of Frank Salive. With decades of race calls to his credit and a wide and varied career resume besides, Salive will bring his "dulcet tones" to the oldest lighted harness track in North America on Friday (Sept. 27) when he makes Batavia Downs the 75th track that he has plied his trade at.

"Over the years in my travels, Wally Hennessy and Bud Gilmour told me a lot of great things about racing in Western New York and I'm ecstatic to be invited to get involved with this great time of harness racing here," said Salive. "After my time at Pompano ended I tried early retirement from 2012-2014 but I could not shake the racing bug. Now I'm in my fourth season at nearby Fort Erie Race Track and still fill in at great harness tracks like Batavia when the need arises. I'm very excited to be coming down."

A native of Leamington, ON, Salive's first exposure to harness racing was at Windsor Raceway in 1972 at the age of

17 when he saw Albatross compete there. But his career path did not take him directly to the announcers booth.

Salive first played junior hockey with the Peterborough Petes as their starting goaltender under the direction of Hall of Fame coach Roger Neilson. He played there for three years, culminating with an appearance in the first World Junior Hockey Tournament in 1974 when the Petes beat Team Russia in Leningrad. As a result of his outstanding play, Salive was named the top goaltender in the series and most valuable player of the tournament. He was later drafted in the 10th round by the Pittsburgh Penguins in the 1975 amateur draft.

Salive never played for the Penguins, instead opting for a career in broadcasting. He worked in radio and television in Windsor and covered the 1976 Summer Olympics in Montreal for CTV in Canada. Although his broadcast resume grew, his heart was calling him back to the track and in 1977 he took his first professional job calling races at Sudbury Downs. He later assumed that same role at Windsor and in 1991 moved to the number one job in Canada, covering all the harness action at Woodbine and Mohawk Raceway. There he called thousands of races from 1991 until 2005 including such prestigious events as the North America Cup.
