All American Harnessbreds, the Maryland farm that produced 2021 Horse of the Year Test Of Faith and this year's Jug winner Captain Albano, is leaving the standardbred breeding business at the end of 2025.

After nearly 40 years in business, All American Harnessbreds is leaving the standardbred breeding game at the pinnacle of its success. The farm's general manager, Rob Tribbett, said it simply was the right time to make the exit due to the pending retirement of key farm staff.

"It's different than some other dispersals where someone passed away or it slowly went down," Tribbett said. "We are probably having our best year ever on the track. So, it's bittersweet – we love the business and we love the people and the horses, but it's just time to do it."

All American owner, Fred Hertrich III, said the four-phase dispersal plan was set in motion when longtime farm manager Beverly Webb and her second in command, Debbie Pinder, said they were both interested in retirement.

"Beverly Webb has been with me forever," Hertrich said. "She really runs the farm... She came to me and said, 'Fred, I want to come up with a game plan here.' Then, her assistant, who has also been with me for 30 years, she's of the same ilk and does nights for us and foals mares and she's in her 60s and that's not the easiest work."

“And Rob has kind of a full plate, so this will relieve him of that as well, because he’s been an integral part in everything I’ve done. He’s like a third son because his father [Charlie Tribbett] was my private trainer in the standardbred business.”

Hertrich said his two sons enjoy the horse business, but not enough to make it a full-time commitment.

“[Closing the farm] was going to occur sometime because my sons are really not interested in being in the horse business, with the effort you have to put in,” Hertrich said. “They have day jobs.

“We’ve spent a lot of time doing what we do, to be as successful as we have, and you just can’t do it two hours a week and they understand that.”

All American Harnessbreds was founded in 1985 in the Maryland eastern shore community of Federalsburg. But, it all started with another kind of horsepower. In 1963, Hertrich’s father opened the family’s first car dealership in Seaford, DE. The family still owns what is now Hertrich Buick GMC of Seaford, but is now involved in 24 dealerships in all, along with 19 brands, and 12 Collision Centers across four states: Delaware, Maryland, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania.

“I have one car dealership in New Jersey and it was called All American Chevrolet,” said Hertrich. “The [farm] name came from that. We were trying to [establish] what kind of athlete we wanted to produce. All Americans was pretty much just what we were looking to produce.”

NEWS COMES ON THE HEELS OF JUG WIN

Tribbett first shared the news of All American’s phased closure with HRU the morning after Captain Albano, bred by Hertrich, won the Little Brown Jug.

“We’re currently the fourth-leading breeder in earnings this year and that doesn’t include Nijinsky [bred by Jeffrey Snyder]

because we bought the mare carrying him, but we foaled and sold him," Tribbett said. "But we have [a strong connection to] two of the top three pacing colts of the year with Captain Albano and Nijinsky – a North America Cup and a Jug. We hadn't won either of those races before.

"Buy A Round was second in the Hambletonian Oaks and she's made about \$700,000.

"Cant See Me was third in the She's A Great Lady final on Saturday at Mohawk. She was an elim winner.

"Act Fast is a tough free-for-aller as a 4-year-old for Ron Burke.

"So, it's been a great year and it just made the timing [to liquidate] feel right because we feel like we're going out on top."

Horses bred by Hertrich have earned over \$4.1 million this year. He ranks behind perennial leaders Hanover Shoe Farms (\$26.2 million), Winbak Farm (\$15.6 million) and Crawford Farms (\$6.9 million) in the breeder rankings by earnings. Hertrich said he's proud All American is going out after one of its most successful years in the business.

"Watching Captain Albano win the Jug or, you know, being in Kentucky last year and back-to-back Buy A Round and Captain Albano won two big races, those are thrills that give credibility to what you attempted to do," he said.

"The biggest takeaway is that [closing down operations] just works for our key people and they really designed the plan for

the liquidation, as far as it being an orderly and correct way to do it, without sacrificing the health of any animal or making them different than they would have been if we were still operating and still in business. In fact, each animal will probably get more individual care next year than this year."

FOUR-PHASE LIQUIDATION

Tribbett said All American will sell its assets in four phases and exit the standardbred breeding market at the end of 2025.

He said All American yearlings will sell this year both at Lexington and Harrisburg as normal. The in-foal mares will be sold in the mixed sale portion of this year's Standardbred Horse Sales Company auction in Harrisburg, PA, along with the majority of the farm's stallion share interests.

"Then, in 2025, we're holding over our weanlings of this year to sell them as yearlings as we normally would next year," Tribbett said. "Then, next year at Harrisburg, the remaining barren mares, barren of '24, will be sold at the mixed sale in '25 along with the balance of the stallion shares that we're holding over to breed those mares next year.

The objective is to have a complete dispersal of the farm by the first week of November, 2025.

Tribbett said the dispersal will be a great opportunity for some other breeders to land quality stock.

"I think that's the most exciting part," Tribbett said. "We have, over the years, developed methods of buying mares and finding those mares... We're very selective in what we bring in, but I think our methods of doing that have allowed us to curate a band of mares that have created horses like Captain Albano, Nijinsky, Test Of Faith, Stag Party.

"None of those were six-figure mares but I think some of our methods of trying to identify those mares was important... Not only are those mares going to be sold, but also there are plenty of young mares that we've added in recent years that may only have one or two foals. I think in two or three years they might be the dam of a Jug winner or the Horse of the Year, because we really don't have a huge band of mares. All these mares were carefully selected by Fred, Bev and myself to be mares that we think can produce great racehorses, because that's always our goal. It's not just about sales, but it's about making horses like Test of Faith.

"We've done that in lots of different ways. It's not just that they were all bought at sales – they were bought privately or online."

"There are lots of younger mares that we're excited about and we're interested to see where they end up. I think there's going to be an opportunity for some of the new players in the game and some of the players who have arrived in jurisdictions to get their hands on mares that we've kind of already done the hard work on. We've selected those and bred them in ways that we think the future is very high.

"[Closing the farm] was going to occur sometime because my sons are really not interested in being in the horse business, with the effort you have to put in. They have day jobs. “We’re also offering in this group Buy A Round herself... She’ll race in Lexington and then in the Breeders Crown before she [is sold]. Then, the complete, no reserve, wind down of the assets will occur next November.”

Also being sold this fall is Nijinsky’s dam, Pirouette Hanover. She foaled a Captaintreacherous colt in June and was not bred back.

THE MARKET HAS NEVER BEEN BETTER

As for the industry itself, both Hertrich and Tribbett said they are bullish on it.

“This was the time to exit because, selfishly, the market has never been better, the industry in my estimation has never been better,” Hertrich said. “So, as a result, it’s a great time to pull the plug.”

“We think the standardbred business is super healthy,” Tribbett said. “Obviously, the Freehold [Raceway closure] news was disappointing, but if you look at it across all the jurisdictions, I think the money in New Jersey has been reaffirmed. Ohio is rocking and Indiana. Kentucky continues to rise and Ontario and New York, Pennsylvania.

“I think the standardbred business is as healthy as it’s been in quite a long time. So that was definitely not a factor. We’re very optimistic heading into the yearling sales because of the strength we’ve seen everywhere in the standardbred business. It is a great time to own a standardbred racehorse.”

Tribbett said Hertrich will remain in the thoroughbred business in Kentucky.

“Part of it, as well, is that running two large farms, 650 miles away from each other, is challenging,” Tribbett said. “So, that’s certainly part of the equation. Also, our farm in Maryland is a challenging place to do a lot of the things we have to do with staff and vendors, so that certainly played a role.”

Both Tribbett and Hertrich said they will remain in the standardbred business in some capacity.

“I’m still going to buy a racehorse for friends of mine or partners like John Fielding,” Hertrich said. “I’m still going to be involved, but we’re not going to be involved [in breeding] because it’s so difficult to do it well and compete, because we don’t go buy the \$300,000 fillies or mares. There’s a distinct way we have bought all our mares that are in our broodmare band. To duplicate that, would be to put a whole organization back together again, so the timing just feels right.

“If I was 39, I wouldn’t be having this conversation.”

“We’re not going to be ignoring the [standardbred] business,” Tribbett added. “It’s just that the breeding business takes a large level of capital and time, so that’s kind of part of the decision.”

BACKSTRETCH WITH GORDON

with GORDON WATERSTONE

Backstretch With Gordon: Season 22 Premier!

I knew my first trip to The Red Mile backstretch on Tuesday (Sept. 24) was in jeopardy when I heard a crack of thunder at 7:35 a.m. And as Garth Brooks sings, the thunder rolled. And it rolled. And the lightning struck. And the rain fell.

And while I first woke up excited as a kid on Christmas morning to make my trip to The Red Mile, my plans for the first column of Season 22 of Backstretch With Gordon went into delay mode. Instead of a planned arrival time of 8 a.m., I finally made my way to The Red Mile at 9:45 a.m. I wasn't expecting to see anything much more than puddles — and I was pretty much correct.

Again, welcome to my 22nd year of writing this column. The 21st century began on Jan. 1, 2001, so it's hard to believe my first year of doing this endeavor began just two years into the new century in 2003. Back then I was working at *The Horseman And Fair World* and it was the brainchild of then Boss Kathy [Parker] to send me to The Red Mile and wander around and write what I saw and did.

So, 18 years of Backstretch With Gordon at The Horseman, and then two years with the U.S. Trotting Association, and now my second year with *Harness Racing Update*. I must thank Dave Briggs for the opportunity to write for HRU, and I also must thank my sponsors, Steve and Cindy Stewart's Hunterton Farm and Hunterton Sales Agency, for their support.

I wasn't sure about the Stewart's sponsorship this year since my agents seemed to be a bit too busy to come through for me. Somehow though, despite Nick Salvi doing a taxing tour of all restaurants in Lexington, and Amy Hollar doing a concert tour throughout Ohio, they were able to put the deal together.

Where we are is getting ready for the six days of major stakes racing that begins on Thursday afternoon at 1 p.m., with the 12-race card including four Bluegrass divisions for 2-year-old filly pacers and five Bluegrass divisions for 2-year-old male trotters.

Afternoon cards continue this first week on Friday and Saturday. Sadly, Tuesday's weather looks to be the norm for the coming week, especially on Friday when remnants of Hurricane Helene will reach the Bluegrass. According to the forecast, those remnants are expected to meander around for a few days so we could see rain every day into early next week.

Tuesday's rain prompted the cancellation of the four qualifiers that were scheduled. As I noted early, it was very quiet at The Red Mile, and by the time I arrived the heavy rain had turned into a light sprinkle. I wandered up to peek at the track and while the main track was closed, a handful of horses were on the inside oval. There wasn't even anybody sitting on "The Deck" or under "The Tree of Knowledge." And the breakfast area was also empty, so no bagel for me today.

I walked over to the barn area and went past the Burke barn and saw the chair where Mickey Burke liked to park himself every day. Mickey was on my list of horsemen who I am most fond of, and I will dearly miss him since his passing last May. Mickey couldn't have been kinder to me over the years and always took the time to say hello. And I easily forgave him several years back when he kept thinking I was Ken Weingartner.

I saw a group over at Bob Stewart's barn so I dodged a few puddles — I was smart and put on an old pair of shoes and jeans this morning knowing it'd be muddy — and made my way there. Bob was there with his wife, Lynda, Andy Miller and John Duer. They were talking to an Australian owner and his son, who soon left the barn.

I asked Andy what he and his wife, Julie, did to adjust training with the poor weather, and he said he moved the schedule up a day so they trained on Monday. I saw that John's son was attending school in Delaware so we talked about that for a second too.

We were then joined by another visitor, a skunk. The skunk went under a car for a moment and then went running across toward Andy's barn. Ernie Hendry was there and as the skunk approached, Ernie bailed. I'm pretty certain that's the fastest Ernie has run since he was a teenager. He might have even beat Tyson Gay in a 100-yard sprint. Without any spraying involved, the skunk then went on his way.

The sale then continues Wednesday and Thursday afternoons at 1 p.m., before a final session Friday night at 7 p.m. Racing during the second week will be on Friday, Saturday and Sunday afternoons, with the closing day card highlighted by the Kentucky Futurity. If you can't make it to Lexington for the trotting classic, the race will be shown as part of Fox Sport's America's Day at the Races that afternoon.

Also, mark down on your schedule this Sunday night (Sept. 29). The special night of dinner and music at the Stable of Memories, AKA The Round Barn, at The Red Mile, gets underway at 6 p.m. and a highlight of the three-hour gathering is the celebration of George Segal and Brittany Farms, as well as all Kentucky

breeders. Trophies and memorabilia of Brittany Farms was recently moved to the Stable of Memories. Before I left the track on Tuesday, I stopped by to check it all out. Former Boss Kathy was there still arranging some of the items, and there are some fantastic trophies won by Brittany over the years on display. It was impressive for me to see the list of 29 Breeders Crown champions who carried the Brittany banner.

Yannick Gingras is heading Down Under

The U.S. Hall of Famer is confirmed for the Ladbrokes Ultimate Driver Championship.

Hall of Famer Yannick Gingras has snapped up the chance to become the second North American driver in Australia's new Ladbrokes Ultimate Driver Championship.

Gingras, who was inducted into the Harness Racing Hall of Fame in 2022, will join former New Zealander Dexter Dunn in the innovative and much talked about 20-race series at Brisbane's Albion Park on Feb. 21 and 22, next year.

"It created quite a buzz over here when word first got out about it," Gingras said. "It's the sort of thing you just knew a lot of drivers from here, and anywhere in the world I guess, would want to be part of."

"It sounds very exciting and it's something new and different. It's also a great time of year in Australia and fits our schedule really well. I love supporting people trying to do new things."

When 35-year-old **Dunn was announced** as the first driver with a confirmed slot in the series early this month, the plan was already being hatched for Gingras to join him.

"I'd had a few approaches," Gingras said. "But it was Mark Weaver who asked seriously and it was the perfect fit. He's a big owner over here and is close with Ron Burke. We all go way back. We all sort of came up through the ranks together."

"I've got a great relationship with them."

Weaver and Burke are part of the syndicate formed by the Australian-based Aaron Bain Racing and Summit Bloodstock (Jake Webster), who united to secure one of the 10 hotly contested slots in the Ultimate Driver Championship.

Gingras, 45, is the just the second confirmed driver.

Between him and Dunn, they have combined to win six Dan Patch Awards for Driver of the Year. Gingras' two wins came in 2014 and 2017 and followed his Rising Star Award in 2003. Dunn won Driver of the Year four-straight years (2019-2022)

Gingras has also been the leading driver by stake earnings on a remarkable five occasions.

This won't be Gingras' first trip Down Under.

"I went down in March, 2016 and had a great time," Gingras said. "It's a big reason I'm so keen to go back."

That was for an International All Stars Driver series in Victoria where Gingras, Corey Callahan and Brett Miller made the trip down from North America. They were joined in the “World” team by Dunn, who was then still based in NZ, and decorated Kiwi driver Anthony Butt.

Gingras finished sixth in the 21-race series which was won by the Victorian-based global trailblazer Kerryn Manning. The “Victorian” team, which also included the likes of Chris Alford, Greg Sugars and the late Gavin Lang, narrowly won the series.

“It was a terrific trip and I met so many great people... many of them my wife [Vicki] and I are still in regular contact with, like Chris and Alison Alford,” Gingras said. “I’ve won a few of these driver series in different parts of the world over the years and by far the best part is meeting new people and catching up with some you’ve haven’t seen for so long. I’m really hoping we can swing it to get some time with Chris and Alison when we come across next year.

“The other exciting part is driving against other guys and girls. We largely drive against the same group of guys here all the time and getting outside of that is fun for a change.

“I know Dexter is going, but I’m hoping this series has a real mix of drivers from different places.”

Gingras said he planned to “make a real trip of it” given the lengthy travel to get to Australia for the Ladbrokes Ultimate Driver Championship.

“We stayed on and had a few days in a beautiful place called Hamilton Island back in 2016, but Vicki and I would like to see some different places this time.

“I was chatting with Carter [Dalgety, young NZ driver spending time in the U.S.] the other day and I think we’ll actually fly into NZ first and then go across to Australia for the series.

“It could be something like flying into Christchurch, visit some stables there, go down to Queenstown for a few days, which everyone says is amazing, and fly to Australia for a few days on the Gold Coast before the series starts in Brisbane.

“It might be two weeks or so all up. We’ve got three kids and the oldest is 12, so we can’t be away from home much longer than that.”

Australia loves a nickname – Alford is called “The Puppet” and Sugars known as the “Candy Man” – so Gingras’ nickname “The Green Hornet” is sure to quickly catch on.

“Yeah, that one obviously comes from my green [and white] colors and was given to me by a journalist, Ken Weingartner, about 20 years ago,” Gingras said.

Racing Queensland’s David Brick, the man behind the Ultimate Driver Championship, was thrilled to hear Gingras was headed Down Under.

“It’s all coming together,” Brick said. “Our aim was for a truly international series with the best from around the world. You

can’t get much better than Dexter Dunn and Yannick Gingras as the first two locked in.

“It’s not just great for Australians to see these guys race here, but hopefully it’ll create interest in North America for the series, too. It would be great for the series to showcase our great racing.”

Summit Bloodstock’s Jamie Durnberger-Smith, who has been in North America spending time with Gingras, shared the excitement.

“We got our man,” he said. “It’s awesome. You know we’re huge supporters of harness racing back home, taking slots in as many new races and concepts as we can. This series is one of the most exciting concepts yet. We were desperate to be involved.

“We’ve got really strong business ties to the U.S., so it brings out worlds together.

“Yannick is a genuine superstar and we’re thrilled he’s so eagerly jumped at the chance to be part of this.”

The Ladbrokes Ultimate Driver Championship carries \$250,000 in prize money with \$100,000 going to the winner. Slot holders will also receive \$1,000 for each race winner.

There is growing speculation a leading European driver will fill a slot, while the best from around Australia and New Zealand are pushing their cases.

The only other “certain” driver looks to be Australia’s most successful Group 1-winning female driver, Kate Gath.

Gath and husband, top trainer Andy Gath, successfully bid for a slot and will partner with the fundraising cause “Team Teal,” which raises money for ovarian cancer.

Kasey Bendix found that the prescription for a happy life is harness racing

Kasey Bendix has come to embrace the unexpected moments in her racing life.

Ask the horsewoman from Hebron, MD, if she ever saw the successes, personally or otherwise, in her future and the response typically starts with a hearty laugh.

"I can honestly say that over my time in racing, I never anticipated a lot of what has happened," she said. "But I think that has made me even more grateful for the times when you experience those highs."

Just like the evening of June 30, 2021, at Ocean Downs.

Bendix, in her rookie year of training, was chasing her milestone first win.

The odds appeared to be in her favor of making it a reality when she sent out Always Strong in the eighth race at the half-mile oval in Ocean City.

Lining up as the 1-2 choice in the field of six pacers, Always Strong, a son of Always A Virgin—Delightful Party, had the services of Jason Thompson that night.

After getting away second, the brown gelding was a half-length in front after three-quarters in 1:30.3. Mid-way down the lane, he was a head behind the 3-1 second choice on the tote board.

From there to the wire, it was a blur for Bendix, who also owns the veteran campaigner.

"Of course it was an unexpected win," Bendix said. "We would pick up checks with him, but we weren't sure if we would ever see him get into the winner's circle. Jason said, 'We might be able to get there tonight.' And when they did, I just stood there and thought, 'Wow... we just won.'"

It took a moment for Bendix to process the outcome.

"I am always screaming or yelling, whether it's a close race or we are way out in front," she said. "Everyone knows where I am when the race is on."

It would be the lone victory of the year for Bendix.

The following season, she upped her win total to six, and then to 11 in 2023.

This year, Bendix has already set several notable career-best marks, including wins, purse earnings and top three finishes.

Did she envision any of it?

Her answer is no surprise.

“Absolutely not,” she said, accompanied by a laugh. “I honestly didn’t.”

Thanks to a sophomore filly, Bendix is perhaps no longer taken aback by the fruitful campaign.

Fancy Like That, a horse she co-bred and co-owns with Virginia Marvel, has been a force throughout the Old Line State.

The daughter of Rustys For Real—Scootin Woody has posted 11 wins and 16 top three finishes from 20 starts in 2024.

“She has been a whirlwind; I am telling you,” Bendix said. “I breezed her and when we were training her down, we were all saying that she might have what we think she has. Until she hit the racetrack, we were all hoping and praying.”

Those prayers have been answered in the form of an outstanding year for the bay filly whose lifetime bankroll stands just shy of \$265,000.

And while Fancy Like That is a menace to the competition, she is also a handful for Bendix and her team.

“It’s her way or no way,” Bendix said. “It’s pretty much a battle of wills. It’s you trying to do things on her terms. When she is ready to do something is when she decides she’s ready.”

Bendix, who currently has four horses in training, three of them racing, is hardly complaining.

“We love her,” Bendix said. “She just has a determination when she hits that racetrack, where she is 100 per cent, ‘game on, let’s get it done.’ I love that about her.”

Although it would be easy to get swept up in the success, her own and Fancy Like That, Bendix has resisted such temptation.

Instead, her focus is on the day-to-day operation of her stable.

“I like to stay in the moment and then go from there,” she said. “There are so many ups and downs in this sport, so you appreciate the good times and understand you will have to face the bad times head on.”

“If I see a horse who might fit into our program, I will consider buying one or two, but it depends on what is going on at the moment for us.”

Horse racing isn’t Bendix’s only career.

Her other role could not be more different than her time spent in the stable.

“Three days a week, I am a pharmacy tech,” Bendix said. “I have been doing that since 2000. As I have had more horses over time, I have cut back on my days working as a pharmacy tech to concentrate more on the horses.”

“I tell people the horses are my stress relief from the other job.”

Bendix has near lifelong ties to the harness racing world.

Her early days were spent as a young fan of the sport.

“I have had family members, off and on throughout the years, who have been in racing,” Bendix said. “My aunt and her ex-husband had horses together, and I would go down to the track with them all the time. When she got divorced, she met Jerry Nock, and I have been helping him groom for years.”

“My aunt and I started buying horses together and as things progressed, we figured I might as well go ahead and get my trainer’s license, and things went from there. We were just talking about how things have flown by so quickly.”

As for what her racing future holds, Bendix is content to maintain the formula that has helped shape her success.

While she would jump at the chance to have a horse in the Hambletonian or Meadowlands Pace, it is all about the here and now.

“I love what I do,” she said. “I get to the barn around 6:45 each morning and we’re usually on the track around 7. If it isn’t a race day, we are done around 9:30.”

“When I am not doing the pharmacy tech job and I am done for the day at the barn, I like to read a book. It’s a good way for me to relax.”

When it comes to the next chapter of her harness racing career, Bendix is content to let it play out like a mystery novel, where the unexpected always keeps her coming back for more.

“My definition of a successful year would be that we accomplished what we set out to do, had a few nice surprises along the way, and got to do what we love,” Bendix said.

USTA debuts graded stakes information in yearling sales catalog pedigrees

Graded stakes information will debut in yearling sales catalog pedigree pages beginning in 2025, the U.S. Trotting Association announced Monday (Sept. 23). The move comes as the result of standards created by a graded stakes committee that was formed in 2023 at the request of major sales companies and breeders, with the support of the USTA.

The purpose of the 11-member committee was to provide the harness racing industry with a guide to the relative quality and racing class of horses by identifying U.S. and Canadian races whose recent renewals have consistently attracted the highest quality competition.

USTA catalog pedigree pages will display stakes grades for 2023 and 2024, as well as Grade 1 winners back to 2021. Grades for stakes will be available for racetracks to use for marketing purposes but will not be ready for past performances until a later date.

“This is an opportunity to promote the Grand Circuit and the top open races this industry has always wanted to showcase,” said USTA vice chairperson Mark Loewe, who chaired the graded stakes committee. “It’s a pretty big thing. This is something that’s been talked about for many years, and whether people agree with the grades or not, it’s something I think the industry has needed for a long time. We really think graded stakes will be advantageous for everyone involved.”

The committee reviewed races from 2021-24 and used tiered purse requirements to establish Grade 1, Grade 2, and Grade 3 stakes. A points system to determine the quality of fields, based on horses’ performances in graded stakes, also was created and will be considered, along with field size, for the grading of races starting in year two of the process. A race may be upgraded or downgraded, regardless of purse, based on its point value.

A stakes race will not be considered for grading unless it has a total purse of:

For male horses – \$75,000 to \$174,999 for Grade 3, \$175,000 to \$349,999 for Grade 2, and \$350,000 and up for Grade 1. For female horses – \$75,000 to \$124,999 for Grade 3, \$125,000 to \$249,999 for Grade 2, and \$250,000 and up for Grade 1.

Purses are based on the host country’s dollar value. Elimination races and consolation races are not eligible for grading regardless of purse. Races with conditions allowing for divisions cannot be graded on total purse, and regardless of

purse, drop one grade. Invitationals with a minimum purse of \$100,000 can be graded.

“We needed a starting point, and purses was the jumping off point,” Loewe said. “As it evolves, we’ll get into purses plus points. This is not something based on one person’s opinion, it’s based on facts and specific criteria.

“Nothing will probably be adjusted for at least two years. We’ve got to give tracks the opportunity to make adjustments and have a little more history before something is done.”

A second tier of purse-based grades was created for state- or province-restricted stakes (R1, R2, R3) and for now will apply only to sire stakes finals. Other restricted stakes will be addressed in the future.

“What to do with restricted races was a big discussion,” said graded stakes committee member Steve Stewart of Hunterton Farm. “If certain horses can go in a race, and other ones can’t, that is not a true graded race. So, we came up with the ‘R’ designation, which I think accomplishes what we were trying to do. It acknowledges success and quality of horse, but also lets people know it’s different from a graded race.

“You’re never going to make everybody happy, but we’re trying to do what is best for the sport. I feel like at the end of the day we’re going to accomplish our goal.”

Stewart said the addition of graded stakes on pedigree pages would create a more vivid documentation of a horse’s accomplishments.

“I think it’s a wonderful thing,” Stewart said. “You want to identify quality. That’s what the job is of a pedigree. It’s kind of like winning an Academy Award. That’s how you’re branded. It identifies you. You’re more than just an actor.

“It really makes a difference. This is such a step in the right direction.”

As part of the process of creating graded stakes for harness racing, the committee reviewed the work done on the thoroughbred side for its graded stakes program, which was founded in 1973, as well as previous standardbred committees.

Chris McErlean, a USTA director and vice president of Penn Entertainment Inc., which operates both thoroughbred and standardbred racing properties, served as an advisor to the graded stakes committee.

“I think the benefits of the grading system are twofold,” McErlean said. “First and foremost, it gives some order and some standardization for the breeding side and pedigree side. There is always the debate where certain races stand in the pecking order for pedigrees and breeding purposes, and this sets some order to the hierarchy of races.

“The second part, and this is something on the thoroughbred side that I think has worked very well, it becomes a marketing tool for racetracks to use to promote their races and attract better horses. Especially at tracks like ours. Charles Town has the Charles Town Classic, which is a solid Grade 2 event. It’s been able to attract horses that have competed in Grade 1 races, won Grade 1 races, or went on to win Grade 1 races.

“People looking for breeding credentials for a horse will be attracted to that type of race. It kind of feeds upon itself. You attract more graded horses and that helps your standing going forward and enhances your ability to attract more graded horses to that race. We’ve definitely found value in that from a marketing standpoint.”

Stewart envisions graded stakes in harness racing making a similar impact as tracks vie to attract top horses, or enhance purses, to improve or maintain grades for their races.

“I think we all wake up in the morning and we’re all competitive,” Stewart said. “When you start grading races, people want to be

a part of it and figure out a way to make themselves better and compete with other jurisdictions. Competition is a wonderful thing. And bragging rights, I guess you might say. If you don’t have a grading system, it doesn’t mean anything.”

Tentatively, the graded stakes committee is scheduled to meet in mid- to late November to confirm 2024 grades and propose 2025 grading.

“This is a fluid situation,” Loewe said. “There will be an annual review. Every year it could change, but it’s not going to change dramatically from year-to-year because then it doesn’t have any credibility. There were a lot of discussions to ultimately come to an end document.”

Beginning in 2026, the graded stakes committee will consist of 11 members serving three-year staggered terms, with the ability to serve three terms. The committee will be made up of two representatives from Standardbred Canada, one from the Hambletonian Society, and eight selected by the USTA. Those eight shall include two breeders, two sales company representatives, three racetrack representatives, and one at-large representative.

Current members of the committee will continue to serve, with their terms expiring in 2027. Current members, in addition to Loewe and Stewart, are Chris Antonacci, Steve Jones, Darryl Kaplan, Mike Klau, Rich Mattei, Mark McKelvie, David Reid, Seth Rosenfeld, and Peter Szymanski.

Minnesota SIRE STAKES REPORT

Dean Magee triples and pilots Bringoverthemoney to fifth straight Night of Champions win at Running Aces

Driver Dean Magee had a stellar showing on closing weekend at Running Aces, chalking up six wins over two nights of racing including three on consolation's night on Friday (Sept. 20) and three wins on the Night of Champions program on Saturday night (Sept. 21).

The most notable of his six pack of victories came in the \$65,000 Championship for older male trotters, as he piloted **Bringoverthemoney** (Money Talks) to his fifth consecutive Night of Champions win.

Magee sent the talented 9-year-old gelding to the front from post 6 and they quickly took command while BP's Lucky Star (Chad Svendsen) got away second and Poko Loki (Luke Plano) settled away in third through the quick :28.1 opening panel.

Al-Mar Spicey Talk (Mooney Svendsen) began a first over bid near the half mile and Iron Sharpens Iron (Rick Magee) immediately followed the cover.

Bringoverthemoney continued with firm control through the middle fractions of :58.3 and 1:27 while stablemate Al-Mar Spicey Talk and Iron Sharpens Iron continued to pursue the leader.

In the lane, Bringoverthemoney kept to his task while Al-Mar Spicey Talk ducked to the inside with a big late surge and those two battled right down to the wire in a thrilling photo finish that showed Bringoverthemoney as the winner by a head. Iron Sharpens Iron was one length back in third in the 1:56.3 mile.

The top two finishers are owned by Joshua Horvat and trained by Katie Horvat.

Bringoverthemoney (\$3.40) now shows 44 career wins and has earned \$440,071 as the richest Minnesota-sired trotter to date.

DP Freedoms Chrome (For You Almostfree) delivered another big performance in the \$65,000 sophomore colt trot Championship, taking command just past the half mile juncture and drawing away late for a 7½-length victory over Last Of Braggert (Mark Mintun) in 1:56.2 to remain undefeated in 15 Running Aces appearances.

James Gould was the winning driver on DP Freedoms Chrome (\$2.10) and the top two finishers are owned by Aimes Racing and trained by Elvin Zimmerman.

DP Freedoms Chrome now shows 22 career wins from 23 races with earnings of \$203,200.

The biggest upset winner of the night was **Al-Mar Puredelight** (Southwind Flash), a 28-1 outsider who made a mid-race move to the lead for driver James Kennedy and dominated the final three-eighths to draw away by 4¼ lengths in 1:59.1 in the sophomore filly trot for her eighth career win.

The runner-up was 111-1 shot Thom Cruise (Plano) and the \$2 exacta payout was a track record \$9,773.40.

Al-Mar Puredelight (\$58.40) is owned by Jay and Eric De Long and Terry Knothe and is trained by Justin Anfinson.

Another one-two punch result was seen in the \$65,000 older male pacing division when **Antetokounmpo** (Easy Again) rallied sharply in the lane to get up by a head over stablemate and last year's winner SB Bodacious (Rick Magee) in 1:54.1 with King Of Aces (Williams Hernandez) home in third.

Dean Magee was the winning pilot on Antetokounmpo (\$19.60) while the top two finishers are both owned by Rick Magee and trained by Mikaela Delgiudice.

The winner now shows 15 career wins with earnings of \$181,648.

The freshman Championship winners included **SHS Southern Pride** (Southwind Flash) in the filly trot in a career best 2:01.1, returning \$7.20 with driver Rick Magee for owners Jay De Long and Terry Knothe and trainer Justin Anfinson; **Peanutbutterfalcon** (Quality Kemp) in the colt trot in a career best 2:01.3, returning \$8.80 with driver Jeff Hunt for owner/breeder Jeralene Roland and trainer Dan Roland; **Skooch's Valentine** (Karpathian Kid) in the filly pace in 1:59, returning \$11.80 with driver Luke Plano for owner Ron Rettig-Zucchi and trainer Liberio Pacheco; and **Swinging On By** (Karpathian Kid) in the colt pace in 1:57.1, returning \$2.20 with driver Dean Magee in the bike for owner/trainer Brett Ballinger and additional owner Darren Taylor.

The other sophomore Championship winners included **El Parrandero Q** (Wind Me Up) in 1:55 in the colt pace, returning \$9.20 with driver Jacob Cutting in the sulky for owner Triple Q Stables and trainer Edwin Quevedo; and **Deja Vu Babyboo** in 1:54.4 in the filly pace, returning \$3.60 with driver Nick Roland aboard for owner Van Otterloo Stables and trainer Bob Lems.

The other older-division Championship winners were **Wilamar Spark** (Southwind Flash) in the older mares trot in 1:57.3, returning \$5.20 with Rick Magee driving for owners Jeanne Marquis and Jay De Long and trainer Justin Anfinson; and **Fillister Photo** (Easy Again) in the older mares pace in 1:55, returning \$5.40 with driver Todd Warren in the bike for owners Scorpio Stable and trainer Bob Lems.

Driver Dean Magee, trainer Justin Anfinson, and owner Jay De Long all had triples on the card while driver Rick Magee and trainer Bob Lems and owner Terry Knothe all registered doubles.

Leading sires on the Night of Champions program were Southwind Flash and Karpathian Kid with three wins each, and Easy Again with two wins.

HAUSER, PARIS AND MAGEE TEAM UP FOR CONSOLATION WINS

The Friday night (Sept. 20) program at Running Aces featured five Minnesota-sired consolation events, with each event going for \$15,000.

Driver Dean Magee and trainer Adam Hauser swept the first three consolation races of the night, including two wins for the ownership team of Carol and Tyson Paris.

My Man Mahomes (Bat Wing) scored the biggest touchdown of his young trotting career in the freshman consolation for both fillies and colts.

Magee went right to the front and they never looked back, maintaining a comfortable lead throughout and then drawing clear for a 2¾-length victory in a career best 2:02.1 mile over Battle Princess (Chad Svendsen) and Flashing Tens (James Gould).

My Man Mahomes (\$4.60) now shows four wins from 19 career starts for team Paris and Hauser.

They sent out **Mama's Sunshine** (Special Forces) as the favorite in the freshman filly pace consolation and she also delivered a gate-to-wire performance in a career best 1:58.4 holding gamely to win by a neck over Easy Arm Photo (James Kennedy) with Miss Street Dancer (Nick Roland) home third.

She returned \$3.20.

Magee and Hauser completed a triple when **Lovely Normajean** (Fancy Schmansy) led every step in the sophomore filly pace

in a career best 1:56.4, getting home a half-length better than Fiftyshadesofcray (Roland) with Overthemoonforyou (Jeff Hunt) getting third.

Lovely Normajean (\$2.80) is owned by Cara Hauser.

El Travino (Western Trademark) delivered a huge win as the heavy favorite in the freshman colt pace with a 10½-length tally in a career best 1:57 mile over Ten K Obo (Svendsen) and Kid Crackin (Hunt).

Brady Jenson was the winning trainer/driver for lessee Brandon Jenson. El Travino returned \$2.20.

Dance Traveler (Mooney Svendsen, \$11.80) posted a big mid-race move to close in on longshot leader Sign Of The Times (Chad Svendsen) and he then surged past late to post a three-length victory in 1:54.4 while Jeremy's Alibi (Luke Plano) rallied for third in the older male pace consolation.

The winner is a son of Up Front Brad and is owned by QKS Racing and Marianne Foreman and is trained by Quentin Schneider.

BRADY JENSON HONORED AS 2024 LEADING DRIVER AND LEADING TRAINER

Brady Jenson, 28, has captured his first career meet title, taking top honors as both the leading driver and leading trainer at Running Aces in 2024.

Jenson was honored on Friday night (Sept. 20) with a special winner's circle presentation. He was joined in the celebration by a large group of his team members, family and close friends.

Jenson, after adding a driving and training double on the Friday night program, currently has 85 driving wins and 57 training wins this Aces season, which wrapped up on Saturday (Sept. 21).

His current leading margin amongst drivers is a very robust 42-win advantage and his current margin at the top of the trainers list is a 10-win advantage.

After the ceremony, Jenson said: "It's been a great summer and I'm thankful for the team of people we have working together achieving all our success. The horses as a whole have performed beyond our expectations and they were the true engine behind our accomplishments. I'd also like to thank all of the owners and trainers who provided me with driving opportunities throughout the summer."

Creatine retired from breeding

Diamond Creek regretfully announced Monday (Sept. 23) that Creatine (Andover Hall–Berry Nice Muscles) will be retired from breeding.

Creatine has struggled with issues that continue to affect his ability in the breeding shed. With advice from industry professionals and our partners at Sugar Valley Farm, Diamond Creek has decided that it is best to retire Creatine for the welfare of the stallion.

Creatine retired with over \$2 million in earnings and wins in the Breeders Crown, Kentucky Futurity, Allerge Trot and two Group 1 events in Europe. His best offspring was superstar Jujubee, the 2021 Dan Patch Trotter of the Year and 3-Year-Old Trotting Colt of the Year, who became the first sophomore trotting colt in history to record multiple sub 1:50 wins.

Other top performers from Creatine include stakes winners Take All Comers (\$859K) and current 3-year-old Hung Over (\$337K). In total, he has sired 27 horses to reach six figures in earnings.

“He had a rough start as a yearling with an injury that no trainer would take, then to go on to make \$2 million for the farm - he owes us nothing,” said Diamond Creek’s Adam Bowden. “He was our first real homebred and will always have a special place in our history and hearts.”

Creatine will live out his days at Diamond Creek Farm in his new role as a teaser stallion and retiree.
