Cross trainees look to score in Ohio Sires Stakes finals

Conditioner has overcome a stroke to have two top Ohio-bred freshman trotters

Drawing a poor post position in a sire stakes final could be heartbreaking, but for Ohio trainer Steve Cross, drawing a pair of post sevens has been the least of his problems this year.

Cross is the conditioner of a pair of the Buckeye state's best freshman trotters, Black Magic (\$207,578) and Truly Relentless (\$138,511), and strong contenders in Saturday's (Oct. 1) Ohio Sire Stakes finals at Hollywood Dayton Raceway.

Cross, who recently turned 67 years-old, suffered a stroke on Dec. 31 that has left him without the use of his left side.

"We trained (at MGM Northfield Park) that day and when I was going home from the barn, I had a stroke," said Cross. "Numerous horsemen came down and started jogging for me. Don McKirgan and my son (Kevin) did all of the training. They really kept the barn going until I was able to start coming back."

The assistance allowed Cross and his wife, Tish, the opportunity to take care of his health.

When Cross returned to the backstretch, a pair of his freshmen trotters that he selected from the 2021 Ohio Select Sale started to turn some heads.

Cross picked out a Full Count colt by the name of Sudden Lee for \$65,000 and Long Tom filly by the name of Evening Drive

for \$43,000. He signed for both yearlings for Richard Gutnick, who changed their names to Black Magic and Truly Relentless.

Gutnick then added Thomas Pontone and Joseph Lozito, Jr. to the ownership line.

"I give a lot of the credit to Mr. Gutnick. I told him what I liked and he went along with it. That makes it very easy when you have an owner that is willing to pay a higher price for better horses," said Cross.

Truly Relentless started her season in a qualifier on June 2 against her stablemate Black Magic, winning by a head in 2:00.4. Close finishes would become the norm for the filly. She was second in her first pari-mutuel start at The Meadows and second in the \$150,000 Next Generation at Eldorado Scioto Downs (July 4) – both defeats by a neck.

Black Magic started his career with a pair of wins at The Meadows – the fastest in 1:57.2 – earning a spot in the \$150,000 Next Generation Event.

The colt went off as the lukewarm favorite and defeated a solid field by a head in 1:57.1.

After the Next Gen events, Truly Relentless rattled off three straight wins, including the first two OHSS legs and the \$67,000 Ohio State Fair trot. She was a competitive second and third in her remaining two OHSS legs – finishing tied for second in the season-long points standings.

Black Magic matched his stablemate's two wins, a second and a third in the preliminary legs.

Both trotters will leave from post #7 in the respective \$300,000 finals.

"It is what it is, said Cross. "(Post seven) is not ideal. They're both very nice horses and they can race from any post.

"Unfortunately, (Truly Relentless) has drawn bad all year long. She won the State Fair out of the nine hole. She's had a lot of bad posts, but she's been a very nice horse all year."

Black Magic will square off against maybe the deepest field of the eight OHSS finals.

"You've got three track record holders. You've got two world record holders (Rumble Strips and A Real Legend)," said Cross. "What a nice group of horses you've got in the state of Ohio."

Both of the Cross trainees will have the services of driver Chris Lems, who Cross gives a lot of credit his trotters success and development.

"At the beginning of the year, I told him, 'I've got a couple of nice two-year-olds and I'd like you to drive them.' He told me, 'I don't really like to travel unless it is something special. If it is something special, I'll do it.'

"I appreciate everything that he's done."

After the OHSS finals, Truly Relentless will be sent to trainer Linda Toscano to begin prepping for the Breeders Crown.

As for Mr. Cross?

"I was ready to retire. I only train for Mr. Gutnick. He won't let me retire," joked Cross.

"He's a very nice and generous man. He told me that he has 100 per cent faith in me and that I would do the right thing."

Cross recently added a pair of Long Tom yearlings to add to his current stable of three.

The eight \$300,000 Ohio Sire Stakes Finals will headline the \$3.4 million card at Hollywood Dayton, which also has four \$250,000 Dayton Derbies.

Dayton Raceway poised for record night

Saturday night (Oct. 1), Hollywood Gaming Dayton Raceway will play host to Ohio Super Night for the first time, as well as contend four separate Dayton Derby races, one of which includes the sport's number one attraction. All told, purses for the all-stakes card total \$3.4 million, and the track's all-time record handle of \$850,522 set last December, seems all but certain to be shattered.

Just a week and a half removed from the Little Brown Jug, it'll be quite the two-week period for harness racing in Ohio. Following eight Ohio Sire Stake Championship races and three Dayton Derbies, the card will conclude with the Dayton Derby featuring Bulldog Hanover. A 1:45.4 winner earlier this year and a 1:46.3 winner last out at Hoosier, will he be able to break the fastest time ever on a five-eighths mile track of 1:47, currently held by Sweet Lou? Even with the anticipation rightfully brought forth by Bulldog Hanover being in the house, it shouldn't detract from the quality of the Ohio Sire Stake championships.

The OHSS championship for 3-year-old colt pacers gets the limelight as being carded in the penultimate race of the night, immediately preceding the Dayton Derby. Highlighted in that race is Little Brown Jug winner Bythemissal. A supplemented winner to the Jug, Bythemissal seeks to bolster his resume with a win in his OHSS as he becomes the second consecutive Ohio-bred 3-year-old colt pacer (Charlie May from last year) to remain squarely in contention with Beach Glass for divisional honors. He'll need to contend with familiar rival Gulf Shores who starts to his inside from the rail, along with Sling Shock who comes off a lifetime best mile of 1:49.3 from Delaware on Jug Day, as well as another sub 1:50 mile two back. He couldn't get to either Gulf Shores or Bythemissal at Scioto races in July or August but maybe he can now.

Starting now from the top of the card, the OHSS championships begin with the 2-year-old colt trotters. Rumble Strips makes his first start since that win during Jug week when he set a new world record with his 1:53.2 win over the Delaware half-mile oval. He had the benefit that day of starting from and never

having to leave the rail, but that was really a dominating effort. Contenders that had gotten close to him before – and beaten him – such as Black Magic and A Real Legend were raced into submission that day by Rumble Strips. He might be able to intimidate them on the front end.

In the OHSS for 2-year-old pacing colts, it seems like a duel between Act Fast and Racing Rampage. The latter got the better of the former last out on Jug day, but it could be a different story now. In that race, Racing Rampage made the front, while Act Fast was fourth away from the second tier. He actually did get second over cover, but his first over cover stalled and went backwards. Post positions are largely reversed now. Downrightdelicious has shown the ability to compete with these though is hindered by the post.

The OHSS for 2-year-old trotting fillies is an intriguing one. Rose Run Yolanda has been huge in her young career and would be unbeaten if not for that interference break in her first lifetime start – a race she still almost won despite it. She's yet to go as fast on paper as some of the others but you get the impression she may be the classiest. A host of others may not be far behind, including a trio that raced together at Delaware last week. In that race, Rose Run Yanae prevailed in a race where she pulled pocket, looked as if she were going by easily before having to fight her way through the lane to earn the narrow win. Global Girl was equally game in that race, and Truly Relentless was right there as well though could have quickened a bit more off the good trip.

It's another competitive showdown coming in the OHSS for 2-year-old colt pacers. Fear Of Sports has been the heaviest of favorites in his last five races, all of which he's won, but the outside post could make things hard. Two back at Northfield he got first run at a longshot leader and cleared, only to be chased home gamely by Cruise Alert who now will start from the rail. The concern for Cruise Alert is not having raced now in almost a month following the sick scratch on 9/18, but any number of his prior tries may be good enough to turn the tables. McSeaside will try to replicate that Scioto mile from 8/19.

In the OHSS for 3-year-old colt trotters, Rose Run Xtra tracked the every move of Longshot two back at Northfield and just got up in that race to win by a neck. Both also went onto win their next-out races at Delaware and likely won't be too far apart from each other in this race with starting from the two inside posts. Caviar Gold went a big mile three back at Northfield after spotting an insurmountable amount of ground to Rose Run Xtra; an aggressive try will be coming from the outside and maybe he can pick up both the inside two.

Gabby's C Note has been unbeatable almost all year and the OHSS championship for 3-year-old filly trotters seems like hers to win or lose. Hasn't lost in as far as I can see, and someone will need to step up to win. Abbey D has been noticeably improved in her last pair with new trainer Powell; was only a half-length behind Gabby last out at Delaware. Criquette Hall has threatened on occasion too.

One of the other big Ohio names on the card is Sea Silk, who looms a heavy favorite in the OHSS for 3-year-old filly pacers. She was game in defeat last week in the Jugette final, fending off first-over pressure only to have Treacherous Dragon slip out from the pocket and nail her in the final stride or two. She's righted the ship after maybe a slower start to the season as expected and has been awesome in recent months.

In the Dayton Oaks Derby, Bella Bellini comes off a win in the Caesars Trot last out at Hoosier and will continue to be the one to beat for Nifty and Dunn. She may have to do it off the pace once again as the outside post could complicate things a bit. Atlanta is winding down on her storied career and that was a nice rebounding win last out at Delaware following the Maple Leaf trot when she gave way. Both When Dovescry and Refined were no match for her when they met less than ten days ago. Herculisa has surprised against these types before.

Back Of The Neck seeks to defend his title in the Dayton Trotting Derby, a race he surprised in last year. He couldn't be coming into this race at a better time, having upset again last race in the Maple Leaf Trot, and Tetrack retains the drive too. Lovedbythemasses put in a great first-over try two back against Cuatro De Julio and then had a rough trip last out in the Caesars at Hoosier. Amigo Volo continues to be amazingly consistent and Dunn will find a way to get involved from post eight if good enough. Jujubee's delayed return has been ominous thus far through two starts; this seems like a tall ask at the moment.

In the Dayton Distaff Derby the road goes through Test Of Faith as usual. No Win No Feed comes off two strong sweeping finishes at Hoosier and has a more realistic shot against Test Of Faith than she did in the Cleopatra. Kobe's Gigi has been trying to come back to that Lady Liberty race on Hambletonian Day when she pulled the 50-1 shocker. Fire Start Hanover has been a puzzler this year. Gia's Surreal may take an early shot from the outside.

In the race of the night, Bulldog Hanover seeks to keep his dream season going in the Dayton Derby. Carded as the last race of the night approaching the witching hour, he may not have it easy from post eight. Yes, he was unbelievable once again last out in another record setting performance in the Hoosier Pacing Derby, but Allywag Hanover wasn't bad either when he suffered a shuffle that took him out of the race, and now the posts are reversed. I don't know if he'll win, but I do expect Allywag to put up a fight and the race could be closer than expected. In a race where the three best horses drew the three outside posts, Charlie May has the misfortune of post 9. He was tremendous two back in winning the Ewart in 1:48.3 but seems like he would need some luck starting outside of Bulldog. Any sub 1:47 mile would break the all-time speed mark on a five-eighths mile track.

getting ready for a night at Flamboro Downs, training on the job in his new career. Portuondo is bravely trading his status as a popular and well-liked Canadian racing celebrity to take on one of the most unappreciated roles in the Ontario industry: a full-fledged Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario racing official.

The foundation is there. Portuondo's involvement in harness racing began in his early teens, before subsequent involvement with thoroughbreds and quarter horses. It's a fact often missed because of his 20-year involvement as a presenter at the Sovereign Awards, Canada's top honors for thoroughbreds.

"Because of my being a Black person, and you know there aren't a lot of Black people in harness racing, people right off the bat think of me as a thoroughbred guy," he told HRU. "I actually started with harness horses first. I started down at Greenwood with a trainer by the name of Harold Stead. I'm dating myself there! My uncle has always owned harness horses and he's the one that got me into racing." Portuondo's uncle, Maurice Bygrave, still owns harness horses.

"He's in his early 80s. He's still a dentist; he's still practicing."

Getting to Toronto's Greenwood Raceway required dedication from the young standardbred caretaker who even today declares himself "a Mississauga person at heart." Portuondo recalled spending weekends and summers at the downtown track, which closed in 1993. "I wasn't even old enough to drive," he said.

"There was this lady who would pick me up and she would drive me down to the racetrack."

His equine interests later expanded to encompass Ontario's other two racing breeds.

"I worked with the thoroughbreds and I've raced quarter horses... I was actually going to become a jockey with quarter horses but that just didn't work out. They were just a little bit too high strung for me, so I didn't end up going through with that."

Searching for a career path, Portuondo studied commerce at University of Toronto. "I didn't really enjoy it," he told HRU. "But I didn't really know what I wanted to do."

He graduated from Mississauga's Seneca College of Applied Arts and Technology in 1996 with a diploma in broadcast journalism. Although he joked that it was a "back-up plan", the experience led Portuondo back to racing, albeit in a very different position.

"A friend of mine was running the [campus] radio station and needed somebody to host a show and I said, 'Sure, I'll do it.' So between broadcasting and my racing knowledge, that really helped me get the job at Woodbine in '99," he told HRU. "I know there were other broadcasters who were more accomplished, more experienced than I was at the time, but I think that I got the job because of my racing knowledge, because I had worked with the harness horses and the thoroughbreds. That gave me a leg up on the competition."

Working as a thoroughbred simulcast host, often conducting interviews from horseback, Portuondo built his reputation.

"I eventually started doing the network show," he said. "Back then it was on SportsNet; it was also on The Score; now they're on TSN. I ended up doing both breeds."

He's one of the rare commentators and handicappers fluent in all three Ontario racing breeds, which leads to an inevitable question: "To this very day, people ask me what I prefer, and I tell them the same answer: I don't," said Portuondo. "I love all horses equally. I enjoy harness racing – that's where it started for me – just as much as I do sitting on top of one. So me being the size I am, I'm lucky that I can do both, because if I was a lot bigger – some of the harness drivers are bigger – they couldn't get on a thoroughbred, right?"

After 26 years, the popular simulcast host and handicapper made the decision to leave the job he called "a perfect exacta" and start training as a judge. Racing officials Jim Bannon and Gunnar Lindberg had raised the idea with Portuondo in the past, he noted, citing his communication skills and wide-ranging knowledge of the sport.

"One of the things somebody said to me is, 'Why would you want to leave a job where everybody loves you, to do a job where everybody's going to hate you?'" Portuondo said. "I just figured I've done so much in terms of broadcasting and I don't know what it could lead to. I figured [becoming an official] is an

opportunity where I could still be involved in racing; I could have more of a say, in terms of the integrity of the game. Before, when I was doing the TV show, offering my opinion on horses and who I think could win, it was a lot of fun trying to pick winners and stuff like that. Now this is on a different level, where you're upholding the integrity of the game: You're enforcing rules and violations, and it can lead to more."

Even with his background, the man known to Woodbine Mohawk Park horseplayers as "Porty" has found much to learn on his new career path.

"It's been steep, in terms of learning the rules, learning the logistics of being an official," he said. "The people I work with have been great; they've been really helpful. I think what's really helped accelerate things is that I've been doing the job. I don't have an official vote yet [on judges' decisions] until I take my exam, which I hope to take next month. But I still have a say... They ask for my opinion. I've been doing the job in terms of picking horses for the test barn; calling the starter to converse with them; talking with the vet putting horses on the list."

While Portuondo said he misses his 15-minute drives to Woodbine Mohawk Park and Woodbine Racetrack, he has no regrets about his choice to travel among Ontario racetracks as an official.

"I started out in the month of July; I was at Georgian [Downs]. That was great, kind of easing into it. Georgian is a quieter

racetrack, not a lot of objections and inquiries, so not too much for me to handle," he said. "The month of August, I was at Fort Erie and Ajax; I did get one night at Grand River splashed in there. Then this month of September, it's been all Flamboro. Then in October, I'm back to Ajax and Fort Erie, and then November all the way to mid-December, it's all Woodbine thoroughbred."

No Woodbine Mohawk Park on his schedule?

"No, not yet. I don't know what the thinking was, maybe I know too many people on that circuit, I'm not sure. But at the end of the day, I look at the job like this: If people don't do anything wrong, if they don't break any rules or violate any of the procedures, then there's nothing for us to enforce, right?"

Portuondo has given thought to negative opinions about judges at racetracks. He noted that preferential treatment of star players is a concern across all sports, not just racing, and officials take care to stay unbiased:

"Yeah, I think that happens in any sport. If you're dealing with hockey, if your name is Sidney Crosby or Connor McDavid, you're going to get treated differently than if your name is just Joe Smith or Brian Johnson. I get it. I understand why the drivers and riders, trainers and owners might think that way, but we're there to adjudicate. We're there to be the referee. We don't wear stripes, but we're doing the same thing as any official: We're just making the calls we see fit. We try not to look at who the driver is, the colors on the back of the rider, the colors being worn by the driver. An infraction is an infraction, right?"

"Our sport's a little bit different because, you know, in football, [officials] aren't going to say, 'Did you hold that guy?' In hockey, they aren't going to say, 'Did you trip that player?' They're just going to make the call. This is a little bit of a different sport: It's unique that we do speak to the riders and drivers, and get their opinions. Sometimes we take what they say with a grain of salt because they are friends, some of them, and they will try and stick up for one another at times. So we need to listen to what they say, but then again, we also need to go with what we're seeing on the video.

To avoid any misperceptions, the charismatic horseman said he recently had to decline an invitation to co-host at the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame's 2022 induction gala.

"I don't think I can do that anymore, because now I'm going to be talking about the races that I have an effect on, and that part of my career is over," he stated. "I've kind of hung up the microphone."

Ever the communicator, Portuondo nonetheless had more to share about the current need for racing officials, what the job entails, and his enduring love of harness racing. Stay tuned.

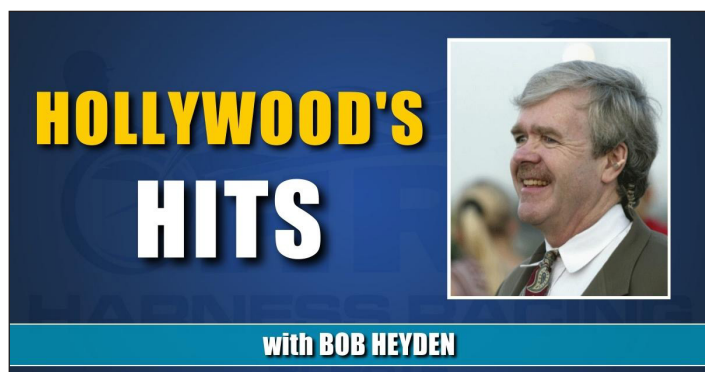

Dexter Dunn was the driver for the Horse of the Year runner-up the last three years: 2019 Bettors Wish, 2020 Party Girl Hill and 2021 Niki Hill. In 2022, he is driving HOY favorite, so far, Bulldog Hanover. If he wins it would mark Dunn's first HOY trophy and could possibly come the same year Dunn becomes the first to win the USWHA Driver of the Year award four straight times.

STANDARD BRED RACING REACHES 500 TRIPLE CROWN EVENTS

The 2022 Little Brown Jug was the 500th Triple Crown race held in the sport's history. There have been 289 trotting and 211 pacing Triple Crown races.

2. Prelude Lobell is the answer to the question of what broodmare was the first to have all her first five foals all take 2:00 marks.
3. Mrs. Frank C. Lewman, wife of the late chairman of the board at Richman Brothers, in 1975 presented Northfield Park with the bell that they used to start races in 1909 at the Old North Randall Fair. That's right folks, a bell over a 100 years ago got things going.

5. The 1976 Kentucky Futurity. 22 Year Old Peter Haughton with Quick Pay won it and still is the youngest to ever win a Triple Crown event. 46 years later and it still holds. He beat out seven Hall of Famers to do it, too:

4th John Simpson, Jr.
5th Glen Garnsey
6th Gene Riegler
7th Stanley Dancer
8th Joe O'Brien
6. The first-ever six-figure yearling came was Dancer Hanover in 1958. He sired the dam of Albatross — Voodoo Hanover. Care to guess where this \$105,000 yearling, purchased by the Stanley Dancer Syndicate, was in the sale? First? First 50? First day for sure, right? Wrong. Hip #914, a bay colt by Adios. He was a half-brother to Thorpe Hanover, the leading money-winning 2-year-old of 1957 and a Fox Stake winner. He was a half brother to Bachelor Hanover (earnings over \$161,000).

Senior care

Amateur driving clubs are moving to strictly limit the use of 15-year-old horses.

Driving clubs are taking a stand when it comes to the safety of equine senior citizens.

"We don't want people racing old, lame horses in our races," said GSY (Gural Settlement Yarock) driving club member Dave Glasser, who recently submitted additions to U.S. Trotting Association (USTA) rule 9.07, which states: "No horse that is 15 years of age or older is eligible to perform in any race except matinees, county fair races, races exclusively for amateur or club drivers as sanctioned by USTA, or non-betting racing under saddle events and no electronic eligibility shall be issued for such a horse except for a performance in such races."

This rule has been on the books for quite some time and when originally written only included matinee races. It was amended in 1999 to include amateurs/clubs, and again in 2008, for county fairs.

"We don't think there is a problem with 15-year-olds racing," said Glasser. "We just want to protect the horses that are in our races. The 15-year-olds draw extra attention because they can only race in our races, and they don't compete with the same checks and balances in the system as, let's say, a 14-year-old does because a 14-year-old can race in any race."

The reasoning behind the submitted additions is that the original rule authors could not have envisioned the opportunities that abound for 15-year-olds in 2022.

The four submitted additions to the rule are as follows:

- Any horse that was placed on the Steward's List (aka "Vet's List") for any lameness during its 14-year-old season is not eligible to race as a 15-year-old.
- Additionally, a 15-year-old horse that is placed on the Steward's List for any type of lameness during its 15-year-old season is no longer eligible to race.
- Fifteen-year-old horses are limited to a maximum of 3 starts in a calendar month.



- Fifteen-year-old horses are limited to maximum purse earnings of \$25,000 during their 15-year-old year, after which, they are no longer eligible to race.

Glasser made this submission with the full support and backing of Bill Abdelnauer (New England Amateur Harness Drivers Club), Joe Burke (Maine Amateur Drivers Club), owner/trainer/driver Stacy Chiodo, Steve Oldford (Great Lakes Amateur Driving Association), Pete Szymanski (Director of Racing for the Ocean Club at Ocean Downs), Tony Verruso (American Harness Drivers Club), Scott Warren (Director of Racing and Racing Secretary, The Meadowlands and Vernon Downs) and Dave Yarock (GSY president), who have agreed to implement these rules regardless of the outcome of the USTA voting.

"We're trying to make this an extreme deterrent," said Glasser. "Trainers shouldn't bring a questionably sound horse of any age to the racetrack."

Much discussion went into crafting these rules and Glasser made sure to include Chiodo, whose husband Bruno competes with the GSY and drives 14-year-old Rock To Glory.

Bruno still needed more qualifying drives to get his license so he could participate in GSY races, so when Rock To Glory came up for sale in March of 2021, the Chiodos took the plunge.

"We had the intention of buying him and just qualifying him every week until Bruno got his license and then we were going to retire him and find him a good home," said Stacy. "And then Bruno's qualifying him and all of a sudden, he's getting braver and braver."

"I asked him, why are you pulling first over in a qualifier? And he said 'I can't hold him anymore. He wants to go, and he really wants to race. I think we should try to race him one time.'"

The Chiodos were pleased when Rock To Glory, driven by Mark MacDonald, won a TrackMaster race at The Meadowlands and then laughed because the horse had to qualify the next week because Bruno wasn't done with his drives yet.

In late 2021, Rock To Glory gave Bruno his first pari-mutuel win and the pair have scored three more times so far this year.

"The horse owes us nothing," said Stacy. "He's actually only about \$30,000 away from \$1 million, so he does have the chance of doing that. I have a soft spot for the old veterans. He's like a barn mascot. He turned into a pet by accident and he's just the coolest horse. We refuse to put him in a claimer because I know somebody out there would probably claim him."

Part of the reason for limiting starts per month and earnings during their 15-year-old season is to discourage monetary elder abuse.

"Amateur races are not supposed to be a money-making enterprise at all for any horse of any age for any driver," said Glasser. "You don't think I make any money on the horses I race in the amateurs, do you? I just try to pay the bills."

THE BRITISH ARE COMING

Prior to the death earlier this month of Queen Elizabeth II, the GSY club had planned a driving competition to honor the Queen's platinum jubilee (70 years on the throne).

The competition, including five amateur drivers from either England, Scotland or Wales, will take place when the fall meeting resumes at The Meadowlands on Friday, Nov. 4.

Friendship races of this type are common amongst driving clubs and this particular event is viewed as a way to pay tribute to an internationally admired monarch who loved horses.

Freshmen's week-one fights highlight today's Red Mile card

The last of the week's stakes action for freshman standardbreds is set to go to post today (Sept. 30) at Red Mile with pacing colts and geldings and trotting fillies in competition in a total of six Bluegrass Stakes divisions.

Freshman pacing colts and geldings get the first bite of the afternoon's stakes smorgasbord in Race 2 with the first of three divisions for the \$327,000 Stay Hungry Bluegrass Stakes. Jim King Jr. trainee Lyons Surfing lands the pylon post in the eight-horse affair off a 12-length rebound blowout in a \$30,000 Liberty Bell division at Harrah's Philadelphia. Tim Tetrick has the drive behind the morning-line favorite as he faces a stacked field including Kentucky Championship runner-up

Bamboozler (starting from post 3), Kentucky Championship third-place finisher Blue Lou (post 2), New York Sires Stakes champ American Fling (post 6) and Elevation Pace winner Ervin Hanover (post 7).

In the following race, the boys come back to town with the second Stay Hungry division. Handlelikeaporsche goes as the morning-line choice from post 8 off a second-place finish in the \$150,000 New Jersey Classic "A" division at The Meadowlands. Dexter Dunn will steer the Chris Ryder trainee against a field that includes Metro Pace finalist Gung Ho (post 2), Metro Pace consolation winner Nazare (post 7) and Elevation Pace runner-up Cant Stop Lou (post 5).

The colts and geldings conclude their stakes engagements on the day in Race 6 with the final Stay Hungry split. Kentucky Goldenrod champ Admiral Hill will try his hand at Grand Circuit company following a seven-length romp in 1:50 over The Red Mile on Sept. 20. Dexter Dunn sits in the bike behind the Chris Ryder pupil and will face challengers including Kentucky Commonwealth runner-up Kaptain Karlos (post 8) and a pair of possible stakes prospects in Christchurch (post 2) and Ammo (post 7).

Race 5 will be the first of three divisions of the \$354,000 Norman Woolworth Memorial Bluegrass Stakes, an event for freshman trotting fillies. The first division features a rematch between Heart On Fire and Kayleigh S after the former landed a finishing blow on the latter to win the \$240,000 Kentuckiana at Harrah's Hoosier

Park on Sept. 23. Dexter Dunn drives Heart On Fire from the pylon post for trainer Tony Alagna while Brian Sears steers Kayleigh S – a full sister to star Joviality S – from post 6 for conditioner Marcus Melander. Division one also includes other burgeoning talent in Kentucky Goldenrod winner Grande' (post 2) and Pennsylvania Sires Stakes runner-up Fashion Annie (post 7).

Division two of the Norman Woolworth Memorial goes as Race 8. The tight betting contest collects nine fillies attempting to stamp themselves in black type including Atlanta's full sister In Italian, who starts from post 5 with Dexter Dunn in the bike for trainer Ron Burke. Nancy Takter trainee Brunella, fresh from a 1:56.1 victory from post 8 at the Delaware County Fair in the \$46,331 Standardbred, scores from post 8 with Yannick Gingras in the sulky. She starts just to the outside of Kentucky Commonwealth champ Yes Please, who attains Matt Kakaley's hands for trainer Tony Alagna. Mambacita, starting from post 1, is the 4-1 morning-line favorite in the race off a fourth-place finish in the Kentucky Championship final and will have David Miller between the wheels for trainer Tony Alagna.

The winner of the Kentucky Championship for freshman trotting fillies competes in the final dash of the Norman Woolworth Memorial. Ake Svanstedt pupil Special Way lands the pylon post in Race 9 off a 1:52.2 pillar-to-post score and will again spar with Walner Payton, who finished second in the Kentucky Championship final. Walner Payton starts from post 5 sandwiched in the Tony Alagna duo of Royal Filly (post 4), a full sister to Canadian Trotting Classic winner Slay; and Una Madonna, who finished third in the \$355,000 Jim Doherty

Memorial. The last Woolworth grouping also includes Quick Stop (post 2) and Secret Volo (post 3), who finished first and second respectively in the \$275,000 New Jersey Classic "A" division on Sept. 16 at The Meadowlands.

Each division of the Stay Hungry Bluegrass Stakes is sponsored by the Stay Hungry Syndicate and Hanover Shoe Farms. The Norman Woolworth Memorial Bluegrass Stakes is presented by the contingent of Arden Homestead Stable, ET Gerry & Peter Gerry, Margareta Wallenius-Kleberg, Stoner Manor Inc., Menhammer Stuteri AB, Jorgen Jahre Jr., LST Stables, Lawrence DeVan and William DeVan.

SOPHOMORE STAKES BLITZ SET FOR SATURDAY BLUEGRASS

Opening-week stakes action at Red Mile will conclude on Saturday (Oct. 1) with a slew of eight sophomore splits of Bluegrass action total on the 13-race card.

Pacing glamour boys compete in two divisions of the \$178,000 Captaintreacherous Bluegrass Stakes. The first division, carded as Race 2, pins Kentucky Championship runner-ups Pebble Beach and Caviart Camden in a rematch and against six other foes. Dexter Dunn pilots Caviart Camden for trainer Tony Alagna from post 3 while Todd McCarthy has the steer on Pebble Beach, winner of the 2022 Pepsi North America Cup, from post 4 for conditioner Noel Daley.

Yannick Gingras drives the Brent MacGrath pupil from post 3 in a stacked field including Meadowlands Pace runner-up Mad Max Hanover (starting from post 4), Kentucky Championship winner I Did It Myway (post 5) and Little Brown Jug runner-up Foureover Boy (post 6).

The trotting glamour boys begin their black-type tangos in Race 3 with the first of two divisions for the \$237,000 Greenshoe Bluegrass Stakes. Hambletonian favorite Rebuff draws post 1 as he tries to rebound from a second-place finish in the Kentucky Championship final. Tim Tetrick sits in the bike behind the Lucas Wallin trainee in a nine-horse field that includes another pair of Hambletonian finalists in Periculum (post 6) and Looks Like Moni (post 8).

Sophomore trotting colts and geldings return to the track in Race 8 with Marcus Melander pupil Temporal Hanover to beat. Brian Sears sticks with the colt who finished third in the Hambletonian following a second-place finish in a final-quarter sprint in the \$275,000 New Jersey Classic "A" division. He starts just outside of Ray Schnitker trainee King Of The North (post 1) and also encounters a late-developing prospect from the Lucas Wallin stable in Pennsylvania Sires Stakes champ Pour Mea Double (post 7).

Marcus Melander also sends the morning-line favorite in the first of three divisions for the \$242,300 Bar Hopping Bluegrass Stakes. Peyton Hanover lands post 7 off a fourth-place finish in the Elegatimage final at Woodbine Mohawk Park and starts just inside of More Than Ever, who just missed a sweep of the Kentucky Commonwealth Series when finishing second in the final by a nose. The first division also includes the quirky gaited Warrawee Xenia as she attempts to make amends from the pylon post for a stretch-drive miscue in the Elegatimage.

Jiggy Jog S, one of two fillies to compete in this year's Hambletonian, scores from post 6 in the second grouping for the Bar Hopping, carded as Race 7. Dexter Dunn has the reins on the Ake Svanstedt student off a second-place finish to Fashion Schooner in the \$275,000 New Jersey Classic "A" division on Sept. 9 at The Meadowlands. She competes in a field which includes Red Mile lover Date Night (post 3), Hambletonian Oaks runner-up Pink Coco Chanel (post 7) and Mon Cheval (post 8), the latter of all finished third in the Elegatimage.

Fillies finish their stakes contests in Race 11 with the final division of the Bar Hopping. All focus sits on Joviality S, the Marcus Melander-trained debutante who has only missed the winner's circle twice in 11 starts. Brian Sears steers the Hambletonian runner-up from post 5 in an eight-horse affair that includes Red Mile speedster Selfie Queen (post 7), who most recently finished second in the Kentucky Championship final.

An overflow field aligns in Race 10 for the lone Bluegrass sophomore pacing filly dash – a \$150,000 event monikered

"The Papi Rob Hanover". Last season's sensation Niki Hill will try to rekindle her freshman-season magic as she makes her third start of the year, entering here off a second-place finish against older competition at The Meadowlands. Dexter Dunn drives the Chris Ryder trainee from post 7 in the 11-horse race that includes late-blooming sophomore Max Contract (post 1), New York Sires Stakes champ Just Divine (post 2), Kentucky Championship winner Boudoir Hanover (post 5) and Kentucky Commonwealth winner Queen Of Success (post 8).

Every Bluegrass division on Saturday is sponsored in part by Hanover Shoe Farms. Each Bluegrass division for the respective sex and gait is sponsored in part by the stallion syndicate for which each is named.

It was her first career start and is trained by her driver.

Driver Montrell Teague notched his 2,000th career win aboard his own Country Courtesy (\$2.20), who was an open length winner in 1:58. A large crowd of friends and family joined the popular son of Hall of Fame trainer George Teague Jr. in the winner's circle.

Night Terror (\$7, Roger Plante Jr.) started the DSBF divisions with a 1:57.4 win, his third of the season. The Badlands Hanover colt was a wire-to-wire winner from post three over Sweetest Swing and Double Bags. Owned by Leblanc Racing, William Lutz Jr., Count De Money Stable and Ronald Jones, the Steve Leblanc trainee was making his 7th start of the season.

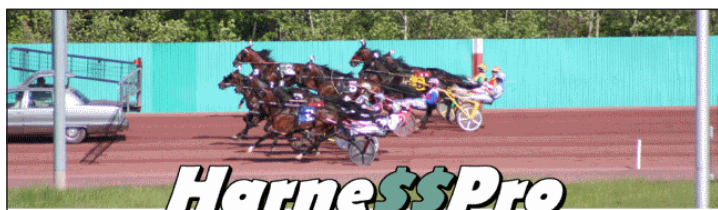


