Million-Dollar Night

The opening session of the 2019 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale saw not one, but two, yearlings sell for \$1 million or more and also smashed records for gross (over \$18.2 million), average (\$154,288) and number of \$100,000 yearlings sold (68, with a record nine yearlings reaching or surpassing \$300,000).

The gross was up 41 per cent and the average was up 22 per cent from last year's record sale.

Hip 105, the Muscle Hill-Danae full-brother to European star Propulsion was sold for \$1 million to Brixton Medical AB of Sweden. It was the second million-dollar yearling sold Tuesday night at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale.

The pre-sale buzz about harness racing's first million-dollar yearling wasn't just hype.

Tuesday, during the opening session of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale at the Fasig-Tipton sales pavilion in Lexington, KY, not one, but two yearlings sold for \$1 million or more on a record-smashing night in every way.



“It was definitely a historic night for harness racing,” said David Reid, who manages the sale with Randy Manges. “It’s really a tribute to the breeders that support the sale. They breed their horses, they raise their horses. The sale has produced numerous champions and it was really great to see everyone come together... I think it’s going to be great for the industry. It’s great for all of us, the breeders. It’s good for the trainers, owners, racetracks. It shows great strength in the industry. We all know this business is resilient, but that was

an exclamation point tonight, selling two for a million, a pacing colt for \$800,000 and numerous others over \$500,000.”

The sale topper, a full-brother to 3-year-old trotting sensation Greenshoe (3, 1:49.4, \$1,016,273), sold for \$1.1 million. The Father Patrick colt out of Designed To Be named Maverick sold as hip 44. Consigned by Kentuckiana Farms and bred by Ontarians Al Libfeld and Marvin Katz, Maverick

was signed for by fellow Ontarian Brad Grant on behalf of The Maverick Group and will be trained by Tony Alagna.

Grant admitted he was still shaking with excitement after signing the sales slip. "He's the real deal. He's as perfect a colt as you could find. He checked all the boxes and we had other people check him out and I'm really happy I got him," Grant said. "I really believed he was going to be a million-dollar horse and when we saw those people from Sweden bought that other colt for \$200,000 it kind of set the

mark. He's worth everything. With Greenshoe doing what he's done and being syndicated this past week, I mean, the colt is the real deal. We're excited."

Grant, who won the 2018 Hambletonian as a part-owner of filly Atlanta, said he wants to win the Hambletonian again.

"Absolutely. It's addictive. You want to get the best horses, whether they are pacers or trotters, and there's no doubt this is the best horse," he said.

Alagna said, “We thought the horse was going to bring that. I talked to a couple of guys and they were willing to go in, so it’s nice that they have the faith in me to train a horse like that.”

“We love the colt. I was actually the underbidder on Greenshoe, so I bid \$325,000 on Greenshoe and he brought \$330,000, so it’s nice to get this colt and have a shot at the family. We’re excited.”


Katz, who talked about the 20-year journey to producing Greenshoe and Maverick in a recent HRU article ([full article on HRU](#)) said producing the sport’s first million-dollar yearling is great, “not only for our breeding program, but great for the whole industry. It sets a high-water mark, but it also clearly identifies that this business is on the upswing and there’s a lot of opportunity here for people.”

The purchase destroyed the record for a standardbred yearling sold at auction set in 2011 at the Standardbred Horse Sales Company’s auction in Harrisburg, PA when brothers John and Tom Cancelliere paid \$825,000 for Detour Hanover, the full brother to Hambletonian winner Donato Hanover.

Reden bought the full-brother to his star Propulsion for \$1 million out of the Cane Run Farm consignment on behalf of Sweden's Brixton Medical AB. Hip 105 is a Muscle Hill colt out of Danae named Damien.

"After Greenshoe's brother (sold), we knew that we'd need to pay a lot," Reden said. "(Damien's) brother (Propulsion) has earned a lot of money so I think (the purchase price) was worth it."

Reden said the original plan was to buy Damien and take him back to Sweden.

"(The owner) wants to bring him to Sweden, but the price was very high so now we need to think a little bit," Reden said. "I hope he ends up on my farm because I have the brother."

Not only did the opening session set new standards for the highest-priced standardbred yearlings ever sold, it also smashed every other record.

The average of \$154,288 was up 22 per cent from the 2018 opening session average of \$126,471 and up 35 per cent from the 2017 first night average of \$114,344. This year's opening session gross of \$18,206,000 exceeded the record of \$12,900,000 set in 2018 by 41 per cent, though this year 16 more horses were sold compared to a year ago when 102 went through the ring.

"We've been saying all along that it was our deepest catalogue and if you just read all of the snippets on social media and in the news, everyone thought the first night was a great night and the best night ever and whatever, whatever, but it still has to come together," Reid said. "There's never been a yearling sell for one million and we sold two. We had strong participation from Europeans and so we've got to really thank them. Our industry has to start thinking more global and I was very happy to see that."

In all, 68 yearlings sold for \$100,000 or more, including 21 over \$200,000 and nine over \$300,000. The number of yearlings that fetched six figures or more was a record that exceeded the 2018 record of 64 \$100,000+ yearlings. In 2018, 64 yearlings sold for \$100,000 or more, including 17 over \$200,000 and five over \$300,000.

The fireworks started early. Hip 7, a Cantab Hall filly out of Jolene Jolene named Ineffable sold for \$600,000 to Lina Alm, agent for SRF Stable of Klagerup, Sweden out of the Hunterton Farm consignment.

"You never think that they are going to bring \$600,000, but there was tremendous interest in her and, basically, anybody that watched the video realized that she was a special filly," said Hunterton's Steve Stewart. "The filly last year, the first

foal out of Jolene brought \$200,000 and she's made \$200,000 already back this year, but this is a special filly. The one thing that I was a little concerned about was being a Cantab Hall, but she was such a special filly. Determination, the people that bought the Hambletonian winner from us, were the underbidders, so those were two heavy hitters going at it and that's what it takes."

Trainer Nancy Johansson bought the third and fourth highest-priced yearlings and led all buyers in gross purchases, spending \$1,760,000 to bring home five yearlings. Determination Stable spent \$1,290,000 to buy four yearlings, followed by Brixton Medical AB (two yearlings, \$1,200,000 total), The Maverick Group (one yearling, the sale topper, \$1,100,000) and Diamond Creek Farm LLC (two, \$640,000).

Johansson paid \$800,000 for Hip 114, the highest-priced pacer in the session. The Somebeachsomewhere colt out of Economy Terror, named Some Terror, was consigned by Vide Carre Farms, Agent.

Johansson also paid \$700,000 for Hip 65, a Muscle Hill colt out of Stubborn Belle named Really Fast. Like the sale-topper, Really Fast was bred by Libfeld and Katz and consigned by Kentuckiana Farms.

"He's a great individual and had everything that we look for... and Muscle Hill doesn't exactly hurt him, either, now we just need some luck," Johansson said. "He has a great pedigree, Marvin Katz and Al Libfeld, they raise great horses, so it's a home run-type of horse that could go stand stud one day, hopefully, if he's racing well.


"The 2-year-old filly this year, Ms Savannah Belle, has obviously been doing really well. She's a fast filly.

"We hadn't really set a limit, we were just going to see how it went with the bidding, but he's a great colt," Johansson said.

As for the opening night crowd, Reid said it was outstanding.

"I came in the back and the crowd was great here," Reid said. "It's been hot, obviously, all week and I walked inside and the arena looked packed and there were people against the walls. I came back out and said, 'This is the best crowd I've seen here in a long time, if not ever.'

"Lexington is special. People come here from all over the world and I'm just very proud to be part of it... There's a lot of history here. More importantly, I said something to a friend of mine the other night, 'You come here and you think about a lot of memories that you have that you made...' We've lost

Breeding a pacing mare to a trotting stallion, remembering when Hanover auctioned two yearling fillies simultaneously and thoughts on the legacy of Bettors Delight

I'm ashamed.

In last week's column, I neglected to give credit to the one person, perhaps more than anyone, who helped me on any road to success I've enjoyed in this business.

Without my long-time loyal and incredibly efficient assistant Vivian Jewitt, any success that I might have achieved would have been diminished, if not totally eliminated. Vivian is the very best.

Last night in Lexington

This column was written before day one of Lexington, which took place last evening.

I don't think that there are many, if any, who do not believe that, at least on paper, this represented the greatest single day's offering in the history of harness racing.

The pedigrees of this group of yearlings as a single offering are without precedent.

Knowing that the individuals were individually judged by my two knowledgeable friends Randy Manges and David Reid gives me reason to believe that they, almost without exception, were at or near the top of the class in terms of individuality.

Best of luck to everyone who bought them and to those who will be buying yearlings through November.

Bettors Delight

There is no question that Bettors Delight is among the greatest stallions in the history of not only harness racing, but of any equine pursuit.

He leads all breeds by a large amount as the greatest money-producing sire in equine history.

If only USTA and/or Standardbred Canada would add his Down Under earnings to those achieved by his offspring in North America.

He consistently sires great colts and fillies and has done so every year that he has stood at stud.

His offspring are generally among the most durable of any stallion around. They keep racing to ripe old ages and generally stay pretty sound.

Most amazingly, he is arguably enjoying his most successful year at the ripe old age of 22.

Yet, despite all these great attributes, he can be a breeder's nightmare.

When you breed to him, you don't know what you are going to get.

In the majority of cases, you will likely get a smallish, plain-looking individual who is generally correct, but who's appearance will often belie the speed inherent lying underneath.

They often do not sell nearly as well as they should.

Occasionally, you will get a good sized, strong, great looking individual like Tall Dark Stranger and the breeding will pay dividends. You can also get a flashy, medium-sized horse like Betting Line who will also pay its way.

Ironically, Bettors Delight's sire Cams Card Shark, also a great but often under-rated stallion, had similar problems when they sold as yearlings, not because they were small, but largely because they were deemed unattractive, with a good many of them not having the prettiest of heads and being benched kneed.

Topic on Facebook

Rene Allard said that he was considering breeding a good Western Ideal pacing mare that he owns to a top trotting stallion.

The mare herself was a very good race mare. She has had three foals of racing age, all by pacers, who are decent pacers.

Rene said that the mare herself showed an inclination to trot and he had trained her on the trot in 2:10.

He asked what people thought of the idea. The vast majority of the people who responded said, "Don't do it."

I felt I wouldn't do it if I owned the mare, but if Rene was willing to take the gamble, then why not?

Rene said that he had made up his mind and that he was going to do it.

I mentioned that Norman Woolworth bred the terrific pacing mare Glad Rags to Nevele Pride and got the wonderful racehorse and sire Zoot Suit.

The discussion went on to which trotting stallion the mare should go to.

Rene said that the mare toed out and he would like to stay away from a stallion that toed out. That would eliminate Muscle Hill.

Yannick Gingras said that he thought Father Patrick would be a perfect cross. I certainly did not disagree. My feeling is that Cantab Hall, his son Father Patrick and FP's son Greenshoe would be strong candidates.

Rene later asked what would happen if you bred a pacing stallion to a trotting bred mare?

I said that has been done far more often and very successfully than the reverse.

Billy Direct was the very first pacing stallion to stand at Hanover Shoe Farms.

At the time, Hanover had very few, if any, pacing bred mares. So Billy Direct was bred to trotting bred matrons who I suspect had a tendency to show some pace.

Billy Direct's greatest son was Tar Heel, who was out of a trotting bred mare. So were top notch horses such as Ensign Hanover and Direct Rhythm.

Many of Tar Heel's best performers, especially in his early years at stud, were out of trotting bred mares. Thus they were three quarter trotting bred pacers.

Among the few pacing bred mares booked to Billy Direct was a mare by the name of Adieu, who was a sister to the superstar stallion Adios and perhaps, more importantly, the dam of a mare by the name of Evalina Hanover, who became the dam of the great pacer and sire Bye Bye Byrd.

Interestingly enough, Bye Bye Byrd's sire Poplar Byrd was a trotting bred pacer.

What does all this prove?

I have no idea, other than if one doesn't try, one will never know.

Question from Jerry Glantz

Q. I was curious about the days when Hanover would parade two yearling fillies in the ring and the winning bidder chose the one they wanted. Whose idea was it? Were you a fan of it? Why was it stopped?

A. I take full blame and responsibility for it.

Let's digress to the time when it began; actually to a few years before.

At the time, Hanover generally retained anywhere from six to a dozen of the best bred fillies. They would be put into training and then after racing, they would become future broodmares. Of course and probably with justification, this put a negative pall on the rest of the fillies that were to be sold at Harrisburg. There were no secrets about which fillies were being retained. Their names and pedigrees were printed in the private Hanover catalog.


The prevailing thought was, "They are keeping the best, we only have a chance to buy the leftovers."

Thus the remaining yearling fillies generally sold poorly.

I remembered reading about Canadian thoroughbred breeder E P Taylor having a policy where he pre-priced all of his yearlings.

When and if half of them were sold, he would retain the rest.

For example, when the great Northern Dancer was a yearling, he was priced at \$20,000. Fortunately for Mr. Taylor, there were no takers.



I thought to myself, "Why can't we do something similar with our yearling fillies?"

Instead of pre-pricing them, we could put them together as pairs of as close to equal value as we possibly could.

The buyers then could be assured that they had the opportunity to buy any filly in the consignment.

People could not say that that Hanover was knowingly keeping the best, because they had the opportunity to bid on and buy any filly.

On the other hand, Hanover would still be able to retain a good number of well-bred fillies to eventually put into its broodmare band.

I thought it was a win, win idea. I took it to John Simpson Sr. At first and for a couple of years he just scoffed at the suggestion.

He said words to the effect that we would be creating a circus atmosphere. My response was "What's wrong with that?"

I persisted for some time as our yearling fillies continued to bring low prices.

Finally, he gave in, more to get me off his back I think and said: 'Let's talk to Tom Caldwell (our auctioneer) and see what he thinks.' Tom thought it was an exciting idea and we went with it.

Tom did bring up one minor question: "What do we do if the winning bidder decides he wants both fillies?" Mr. Simpson said, "We'll decide what to do if we are faced with the situation." Thankfully no one ever did.

It was highly successful. Both ours and the goals of our customers were met. The excitement level in the sales arena was palpable.

We discontinued doing it when the philosophy of management changed.

It was decided that we'd be better off not training nor racing any horses, thus eliminating the likelihood of competing against our customers.

Instead of retaining fillies that might or might not be successful on the racetrack, it was thought the farms would be better served by purchasing already made race fillies and racemares either at public auction or privately.

It accomplished two things. It eliminated the probability of competing against our customers. It also helped to diversify the makeup of the broodmare band by infusing new blood and in some cases new families.

Beaver's sophomore filly trotters favored in Simpson divisions

Chris Beaver will send out the morning-line favorite in each of this afternoon's (Oct. 2) three John Simpson Memorial Stakes for 3-year-old female trotters at Harrah's Philadelphia as he looks to push his training stable to a career high in earnings for the sixth consecutive season.

Beaver's Simpson favorites are among a group of 3-year-old filly trotters, including Kentucky Filly Futurity hopeful **Weslynn Quest**, that has combined to earn in the neighborhood of \$1 million this season. Overall, Beaver's stable has banked \$2.64 million in 2019 and is less than \$5,000 from surpassing last year's total of \$2.65 million.

"I have a fantastic group of 3-year-old trotting fillies," the Ohio-based Beaver said. "I ended up with about 10 (1):55 3-year-old trotting fillies this year and that's really helped the season."

Back Splash, who was one of six Ohio Sire Stakes 3-year-old trotting filly finalists for Beaver as well as a Kentucky Sire Stakes finalist, is the 5-2 morning-line favorite in the first \$30,000 Simpson division at Philly. She has won three of 13 races this year and earned \$61,100. David Miller drives the filly today.

"She's a fast filly," Beaver said. "She hasn't gotten around the small tracks really good this year, but she did win in (a career-best) 1:54 at Scioto. I think if she gets out there and keeps rolling along and doesn't get into a lot of traffic, she can be good."

Pure Chance, who heads to the second Simpson division off an Ohio Breeders

Championship victory, has won six of 12 races and \$167,492 this year. She is 2-1 and also will have Miller in the sulky.

"She's been a really nice filly and she's tough," Beaver said. "I really like her. I think she could make a nice racehorse after she's done with her stakes races."

"I had a full sister to her (Sesame) that's made about \$250,000 in Ohio, so they've been good ones for me. I like (Pure Chance) better though. She races without hobbles and she's very consistent. The only times she hasn't raced really good, she's had a couple trips where she got roughed up, otherwise she's always been finishing strong. She's put in a good effort every time."

Beaver has a second horse, **Stone In Love**, in the second Simpson division. Stone In Love, who will have George Napolitano Jr. as her driver, has won two of 16 races and \$53,078 this season.

"She's a nice filly, but she's not quick off the gate so she always kind of gets in a bad spot," Beaver said. "She's usually finishing pretty good though."

In the third division, **Keystone Abbey** is the 2-1 favorite. The filly has won five of 17 races this year, including the Currier & Ives Filly, and earned \$101,870. Napolitano will drive Keystone Abbey.

"She's been a little bit lucky this year," Beaver said. "She was good that day (in the Currier & Ives Filly), but the favorite ran coming down the lane. She won some races and didn't have to go very fast to win them. She did reel off four wins in a row earlier this year, so things have worked out pretty well for her for the type of horse she is."

In addition to his Simpson Memorial Stakes group, Beaver hopes to have two Indiana Sire Stakes 3-year-old trotting filly finalists in recent Buckette Stakes winner **Sophia Lia** and **Morairtime**. Those two fillies compete in the final preliminary round of the ISS tonight at Harrah's Hoosier Park.

On Sunday, Beaver expects to have Weslynn Quest in the Kentucky Filly Futurity at Lexington's Red Mile. She finished second to Only Take Cash in the Ohio Sire Stakes final and missed by a nose to stablemate Pure Chance in the OBC.

"She's a very fast filly," Beaver said. "I had trouble with her being too hot and making breaks early in the season. I got her straightened out toward the end of the sire stakes season and she set a track record (1:53.3) at Scioto. She has a sister (Weslynn Dancer) that's turned into a good aged horse and she's eligible to a lot of the big races late in the season."

"We'll have to see how she goes stretched all the way out against real good fillies, but I think the pedigree is there and the high speed. She's never had to trot in (1):50 before so we'll see what happens."

Today's card at Harrah's Philadelphia also includes three divisions of the Simpson Memorial for 3-year-old filly pacers. Rockn Philly, So Awesome, and Trillions Hanover are the morning-line favorites.

Racing begins at 12:25 p.m. (EDT).





Grand River Raceway season up 10 per cent; top performers honored

Grand River Raceway closed the book on its 2019 season on Sept. 27, celebrating a 10 per cent bump in handle.

All source wagering on Grand River Raceway's live racing for the 2019 meet was \$10,382,493 for a daily average of \$216,302, an increase of 10.8 per cent over last season. In 2018, 47 race dates were conducted and \$9,366,979 was wagered. A total of 490 races were conducted this year, eight more than last year.

The track's 29th annual Industry Day event on Aug. 5 posted a record handle of \$488,696 — the highest single day handle ever recorded since the track's first race meet in 2004.

Total purses paid for all races at Grand River Raceway were \$4,895,857 — an increase of 4.5 per cent over the 2018 season.

Top performer presentations were made on Sept. 25 and 27 (respectively) to Jodie Cullen and Robert Shepherd.

Robert Shepherd recorded 38 driving wins from 250 starts at Grand River Raceway in 2019. The Flamborough, ON resident recently surpassed 3,600 career wins and \$25 million in purse earnings. He's on target to record his sixth straight \$1 million season and his 13th consecutive season with at least 100 wins. He's currently third in the national driving standings with 231 wins. He's also the current leading dash-winner at Flamboro Downs.

Trainer Jodie Cullen recorded 24 wins and trained horses to purse earnings of \$127,759 at Grand River Raceway in 2019. Nearly half of her 95 starters at the Elora, ON oval finished in the top three, and more than one in four found the winners circle.

The Dundas, ON resident is in the top 10 for wins and UTR in the season's national trainer standings and is currently tied for the top spot in Flamboro Downs' 2019 trainer standings.

Dates for Grand River Raceway's 2020 race season will be released in the new year. The facility is open year-round with gaming, dining and entertainment offerings. For complete details: www.grandriverraceway.com.

Renovations are slated to begin in October on a \$4 million project which includes an expanded Lighthouse Restaurant and Ship In barn that will house a new simulcast lounge, expanded kitchen and event space, administration offices, and a maintenance shop. Two-year-old pacing filly **Alicorn** wrapped up the Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Gold Series regular season on Monday evening with another impressive effort over the Woodbine Mohawk Park oval, matching her OSS record with a spectacular late sprint.

Lining up at Post 5 in the six-filly field, driver Louis-Philippe Roy opted to ease Alicorn away from the gate and the heavy favorites were sitting fifth when Rose Run Vantage reached the :26.3 quarter. The fillies carried on in single file behind Rose Run Vantage to the :55.3 half, but heading into the final turn Roy tipped Alicorn into the outer lane. Temagami Seelster provided a brief windbreak for

Alicorn as Rose Run Vantage paced by the 1:23.3 three-quarters, but Roy was soon showing his charge an open lane to the wire. Once Alicorn dropped into gear she drew away to a two and one-half length victory in 1:50.3, reeling off a :26 final quarter. Pocket-sitter Keystone Kalimba claimed the runner-up share of the \$104,800 purse and Rose Run Vantage was third.

"He said, 'I didn't plan on racing her that way, but behind the gate everyone was leaving out so I just sat back and waited,'" said trainer Chantal Mitchell of her post-race conversation with Roy. "I told him I was a little worried because he was waiting on the other horse, and the other horse that was in front of us wasn't really advancing. I said, 'I thought we were just too far, there was just too much ground to make up,' and he said, 'I wasn't worried.'"

Roy's confidence in the Bettors Delight filly is more than warranted. Monday's win was her third in Gold Series action and her sixth in 10 freshman starts. She has only been worse than second on one occasion — a fourth-place result in the July 8 Gold Series opener at Woodbine Mohawk Park where she paced home in :26.1.

"I really don't have very many words for it all," said Mitchell, who trains Alicorn for Windermere Stable LLC of New York, NY and Robert Muscara of Ivyland, PA. "She just has that desire. She wants to do it, she wants to beat everybody."

Ironically, Mitchell said that Alicorn's fierce attitude is reserved for the racetrack. At home with her paddock-mate Windy, the division point leader plays a solid second fiddle.

"She has a turn out buddy and that filly runs this filly. She's the boss of her. She chases her around the field, and she makes her do everything, she is the boss of her," said the Hamilton, ON resident. "One of the owners said, 'Windy is the boss of Alicorn, and Alicorn's the boss of everybody else.'"

So long as she remains healthy and happy Alicorn will make her next start in the \$225,000 Super Final at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Oct. 12 and then turn her attention to the Breeders Crown eliminations at the Campbellville oval on Oct. 18.

"I'll likely just train her up a bit on Tuesday next week (Oct. 8) and keep an eye on her, make sure she's healthy and she's eating well, and as long as she looks as bright as she does every other day then we'll just keep going," said Mitchell. "She doesn't look any different from the day she qualified to now. It doesn't look like she's dropped a pound and, if anything, she's sharper."

The top 10 point earners from the regular season will compete in the Oct. 12 Super Final and **Betalady** gave herself a chance to join them with a win in the second \$105,600 division.

Starting from Post 2, Betalady left smartly and found herself behind pacesetter All Day Sunshine as that filly reeled off a :26.2 quarter. Betalady continued to sit behind the pacesetter through the :55.3 half and 1:22.3 three-quarters and was able to sneak up the inside late in the stretch for a head victory over Free Flyin Ticket and Off The Press. The 1:52.2 clocking was a personal best for Betalady, who was driven to the win by Jody Jamieson.

"I had the opportunity to drive her for the first time in the Champlain a couple of weeks ago (Sept. 7). She impressed me then with a third and I haven't had the chance to drive her again until tonight," Jamieson said. "The trip wasn't the same as I planned for, but it worked out in the very end. But it took right up until the wire to work out."

It was the first Gold win for Betalady, who moved from twenty-sixth in the point standings to 12th. If all of the fillies ahead of her enter the Super Final the Bettors Delight daughter will be the second also eligible in the season finale, but if any opt not to enter she could find herself with a shot at the \$225,000.
