\$23 million night / SMASNeS multiple records

Diamond Creek bought the session topper Hip 57 Epoch for \$725,000 from Hunterton Farm.

The opening session of the 2022 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale blew away last year's record-breaking first session by more than \$3.5 million. The gross was up 24 per cent and the average increased by 17 per cent.

If last year's opening session of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale was considered jaw-dropping, what to make of this year's first session which obliterated records for gross, average, median and number of horses that sold for \$100,000 or more?

Monday night at Fasig-Tipton, 122 yearlings went through the ring, grossing \$23,067,000, averaging \$189,078 and posting a median of \$160,000. Eighty-nine yearlings sold for \$100,000 or more.

The gross was up 24 per cent, over more the \$3.5 million, compared to the \$18,540,000 taken in on opening night in 2021. The average was up 17 per cent over the \$161,217 from last year and the media was up 52 per cent from the \$105,000 set a year ago and up 33 per cent from the previous record of \$120,000 set in 2018. Twenty more yearlings sold for six figures this year than last year.

The session concluded around 11:30 p.m.




"Coming into it, we were saying all along that it was deep and broad," said sale co-manager David Reid. "When you're bringing new sires and you're bringing first foals and you're bringing world champion mares like Hannelore Hanover and Youaremycandygirl, you're bringing Greenshoes and Muscle Hills and Walners and Chapter Sevens, Captaintreacherouses... You go back through the night – pacing fillies, trotting fillies, trotting colts, across the board it was very solid."


Reid's co-manager Randy Manges said, "Last year our total sale was \$18 million and this year it's 23 million... I was really pleased with the way that 99 per cent of the horses sold.

"A lot of horses sold for \$300,000 or \$400,000 and that's big. I mean, we didn't have a million-dollar horse, but we didn't have that last year, either. A few years ago, that was an important part of the high-average first session."

As for poor economic indicators, Reid said they were trumped by one positive one: high purses.

"There were three economic indicators that were negative and there was one positive," Reid said. "We talked about recession, the currency and the stock market and those were all negative in the general marketplace, but the economics for the horse business is that purses are at an all-time high or close to an all-time high. You've got Kentucky and they came in the last 2, 3, 4 years. Ohio's got a big program. New Jersey added the series in September. Massachusetts is going to go for good finals. You've got Ontario that's announced

next year that it's going to go for more money. New York is status quo. Indiana has big finals there. I don't want to say that our sport is becoming a jurisdictional or regional sport, but in ways it is in terms of sires stakes programs.

"The other thing is that you can't underestimate that when we talk about those purses, a lot of it is Kentucky and the large part of the horses here are dual eligible. I think there's 350 yearlings here that are dual eligible out of 900 and that's a big percentage."

Reid also said there was a strong European presence after two years of COVID-19 restrictions.

"The Europeans were strong here. We had a great crowd and really it's just a credit to the breeders and the people who bring the product here," Reid said. "Some people say it's the best catalogue, but it's hard to compare because every year. You're just trying to assemble the best that you have that year. We're breeding these horses two years ago and whether they are right or whether they are wrong, the sale company is dependent on that. I think there's been a broad representation."

Kentuckiana co-owner Bob Brady said, "We knew coming in the strength of the catalogue. Talking with different people at the farms and looking... there was a lot of quality in this sale. There really wasn't the one horse that they had to have, but every consignor had something and some with very high-end horses, so that's going to spread out the money some, which is actually better for the market because every breeder has a shot.

"This is great for the industry. In the market, it shows there's lots of global support and it's an excellent sale so far"

"She is a lovely filly, checked all the boxes... obviously family, individual, paddock performance," said Shaun Laungani vice-president and director of bloodstock services for Diamond Creek. "We turned her out once and only needed about 30 seconds. We vetted her pretty hard and she was virtually flawless to us. Everybody all day was talking about how she was the nicest in the sale. We thought \$1 million was likely. We never thought we'd even be close. We're just a little above what we had budgeted, but totally happy. Never thought we could get her for what we did.

"Hip 57 was a total surprise and probably the filly that we wanted the very most in the sale. We're super pumped that we got her and I think Chris, Adam (Bowden's) dad, is really excited, too.

"It's just really, really hard to buy ones like that. She has the potential to change our broodmare band so it's a risk we have to take.

"We also bought the Test of Faith sister, Hip 15, and we're super pumped about her. What I thought was a seller's market, we've just adapted and adjusted and it appears to be a buyer's market for us."

Hip 15 Show Of Faith is a Captaintreacherous filly out of Cannae Cammie that sold for \$250,000 out of the All American Harnessbreds consignment.

Adam Bowden of Diamond Creek purchased the sale topper out of Jolene Jolene and the sister to reigning Horse of the Year Test Of Faith.

Trainer Marcus Melander paid \$550,000 for **Hip 70 Vic Zelenskyy**, the Greenshoe colt out of Mission Brief.

"We bought the sister (Jaya Bae) here a couple of years ago," Melander said. "She's a really nice horse, but she has some soreness issues. This individual looked as great as her. Obviously, he is the first colt out of Mission Brief and out of Greenshoe, which I trained... I really liked what I saw. He had great conformation, great video and I'm thrilled to get him.

"It's a lot of money, I'm not going to say it was cheap, but it's still the first colt out of Mission Brief, by Greenshoe, and he looks good, so we thought between \$500,000 and \$600,000."

Melander also will train **Hip 47 Holy Grail Hanover**, the Greenshoe colt out of Holy Grail Hanover that sold for \$435,000 to Anders Strom out of the Hanover Shoe Farms consignment.

"He is also a great-looking colt. He looked great on the video with great conformation," Melander said.

Melander was the leading buyer by gross. He spent \$1,910,000 to bring home eight yearlings.

Montreal's Determination Stable was next with a total expenditure of \$1,525,000 for four yearlings, including the

Hip 63 Awaiting, a Walner filly out of Lonely Lady sold for \$525,000 to Ken Jacobs of Baldwinsville, NY out of the Hunterton consignment.

"It's a sister to my filly (Walner Payton) and she's won \$350,000 and we're going into the Breeders Crown," Jacobs said. "It looked the part. And my other one is doing quite well, so... and I do a lot of research. I do so much bloodline work and video work, so I knew I was going after this horse. Usually when I go after a horse, I'm going to be the buyer. Unfortunately, I didn't think I'd pay that much, but I did."

Jacobs said Chris Ryder will train Awaiting.

Greg Luther of Blacklick, OH paid \$525,000 to buy **Hip 74 Stardust Volo**, a Muscle Hill filly out of Sterling Volo from Kentuckiana.

"We're trying to get to the Grand Circuit stock so I don't want any of the average horses anymore," Luther said. "We're definitely trying to upgrade as much as possible. You get a lot of residual income with the trotting fillies and that's always another option for them.

"This filly here, we gave a little over half a million for her and as soon as I was signing on her, we were already getting offers at \$350,000 and \$400,000 for a broodmare. So, if she doesn't work out, please call me. I had three people ask me that, so it's really a good way to hedge your bet that way."

Hip 51 Slip Sliding Away, a Father Patrick filly out of Ice Attraction, sold for \$510,000 to Jim Glass, agent, on behalf of Marvin Katz and Al Libfeld from the Preferred Equine consignment.

"She's a spectacular individual with a spectacular pedigree. This is what Al and I do, try to find top-level trotting fillies," Katz said.

GREENSHOE MAKES IMPRESSIVE DEBUT

The first crop of Greenshoe were extremely well received. He was the top sire by gross, with 19 yearlings selling for \$4,132,000 in total. His average of \$217,474 was second only to Bettors Delight's \$360,000 average for three sold.

"One thing that you really have to appreciate is how well Greenshoe was received," Brady said. "They sold excellent. People liked them and I knew all summer long that they were going to buy them, because the Greenshoes are correct, they have nice legs, long-legged, and they are very, very athletic."

Fillies dominated the night. Pacing fillies led the way by averaging \$237,333, followed by trotting fillies (\$201,854), trotting colts (\$183,883) and pacing colts (\$148,524).





Hunterton led all consignors with gross sales of \$5,137,000 for 21 yearlings, an average of \$244,619. Kentuckiana was next with gross sales of \$3,485,000.

Reid's Preferred Equine topped consignors in average with \$246,071 for 14 sold, grossing \$3,445,000.

THAT'S JUST THE BEGINNING

Katz said he expects the sale to be, "strong all the way through. I think there's top-level horses here and there's a tremendous amount of money to race for in our industry. The opportunities for racing have grown and I don't see any reason why these horses won't sell well.

Manges said Monday night is just the beginning.

"(Tuesday) we've got some very, very good horses," Manges said. "And it was the same last year, after the first session it was, like, 'How are you going to match it?' Well, you don't match it, but (Tuesday) we've got some very, very good horses and it'll be a good session. Momentum will carry."

Today's session begins at 2 p.m., followed by 2 p.m. sessions on Wednesday and Thursday and a final Friday session that starts at 7 p.m. Saturday is the Mixed Sale. It starts at 7 p.m.







Vernissage Grif winning the \$660,000 Gran Premio della Lotteria in Naples on Sunday.

Alessandro Gocciadoro was victorious when the \$660,000 Gran Premio della Lotteria was held in Naples, Italy on Sunday (Oct. 2) afternoon. His **Vernissage Grif** (Varenne) disarmed the leader and stablemate Vivid Wise As in the final.

Three eliminations were held and trainer Holger Ehlert was the most successful man ahead of the final. Zacon Gio (Ruty Grif), who will enter the International Trot at Yonkers Raceway on Oct. 15, hit the lead after a quarter of a mile in the first elimination and driver Roberto Vecchione had everything under safe control when Zacon Gio came home in 1:53.3.

Ehlert trained Bleff Dipa (Mister J.P.) got a similar trip as Zacon Gio. With a lap to go, Roberto Vecchione put Bleff Dipa in front and from the lead the duo was unstoppable in 1:53.2.

Alessandro Gocciadoro's well merited Yankee Glide son Vivid Wise As was served a second over trip by Matthieu Abrivard in the third elimination and the 8-year-old top trotter played, more or less, with his opponents when he won in 1:54.2.

And it was Vivid Wise As who controlled the field early in the final. Gociadoro's choice Vernissage Grif finished second to Bleff Dipa in his elimination heat and when the trainer found a spot in second over in the final, stablemate Vivid Wise As was without defense when the 8-year-old chestnut Vernissage Grif showed great capacity in the stretch.

Vernissage Grif was flying and captured the leader 100 meters before the wire as he came home to win in 1:52.4. Vivid Wise As was second and Zacon Gio third after a pocket trip.

That gave Gocciadoro his first title in one of Europe's biggest races for older trotters. The dominant Italian trainer has won elimination heats four years in a row prior to this year's edition, but never the final before Sunday's race.

CORAZON COMBO OUTSTANDING IN KRITERIET

Pekka Korpi trained **Corazon Combo** (Express Duo) has dominated the Finnish 3-year-old crop so far and when the \$195,000 Kriteriet was on the schedule in Tampere on Saturday (Oct. 1) afternoon, he was too tough to beat.

Korpi hit the lead in the first turn and when he gave Corazon Combo the order to sharpen the pace at the last backstretch, the 3-year-old Express Duo son answered by sprinting to a safe win in a mile rate of 1:58.4 over 1.6 miles.

Corazon Combo claimed his 16th win in his 18th start and the only defeats so far came in the two E3 finals in Sweden earlier this year.

Halley Wania held strongly as runner up after a first over trip and Everlasting Boogie finished third.

TESSELAAR'S SUCCESSFUL WEEK

Dutch trainer and driver Dion Tesselaar has experienced a great week. On Wednesday (Sept. 28) night, his **Novato** (Maharajah) won the \$140,000 final of Breeders Course for 2-year-olds at Jägersro racetrack in Sweden and on Sunday (Oct. 2) afternoon, Tesselaar's **Gio Cash** (Victor Gio) claimed the \$30,000 Peter Heitmann-Rennen in Hamburg, Germany.

Two-year-old colt Novato bested his opponents in a high paced story where Tesselaar served his horse a perfect second over trip and when the attack was on, the Maharajah son proved to be the strongest horse in the field. A mile rate of 1:56.2 means that Novato set a new Swedish record for 2-year-old trotters bred outside of Sweden.

Gio Cash, who won Breeders Course final for 2-year-olds last year and the final for 3-year-olds earlier this year, took a safe wire to wire triumph in Hamburg and the 3-year-old trotter won in a mile rate of 1:59 over 1.3 miles.

On Monday (Oct. 3) afternoon, the \$40,000 Grosser Preis von Deutschland was held in Hamburg and it became a big success for Johan Untersteiner trained **Indy Rock** (Readly Express). The 4-year-old Swedish-bred trotter has battled against Francesco Zet during two seasons and when Untersteiner opted for the race in Germany, the antagonists suited him well. Indy Rock was pushed hard for the lead by driver Jörgen Sjunnesson and in the last turn the duo said goodbye to the chasers. Indy Rock cruised to a 10-length victory and impressed a lot.

Where did all the judges go?

Jason Portuondo on the need for racing officials.

Earlier this year, **Jason Portuondo** left the broadcast desk at Woodbine Mohawk Park after 26 years, to train on the job as an Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) associate judge. It's not glamorous, but somebody has to do it.

"In a few years, we're going to have a lot of guys retiring, so we're going to need judges," he said. "I think it's a great idea to start programs up and try to get people involved."

The casual fan or bettor doesn't see or know much about the job of a racetrack judge. This makes recruitment challenging.

"It's very unique," said Portuondo. "I mean, we have some people right now that are training who don't know racing."

They must learn the basics of standardbred, thoroughbred, and quarter horse racing alongside the racing rules and how to apply them.

Where did all the judges go? Aside from losing Michael Wilson to the Atlantic Provinces Harness Racing Commission, where the former manager of racing operations for the AGCO and supervisor of standardbred racing for the Ontario Racing Commission started as director of racing on Sept. 6, Portuondo said there is a bigger problem – a demographic one.

"I think it's the same issue we have with racing in general," he said. "A lot of the judges we have right now, in terms of Ontario, are older. I mean, I'm 50; I'm not exactly young myself. We need to get younger blood in racing."

Regulatory roles are the tip of the iceberg.

"Speaking here for Ontario, I know from a training perspective, a riding, driving perspective, even betting, a lot of the core people in this game are older. We need to get the younger people involved in wagering, because without the bettors, you know... indirectly, they're the ones paying our bills."

Judges can and do displease trainers, drivers, owners, and bettors with decisions intended to keep the race card moving and maintain integrity of the sport.

"Regardless of what racetrack I'm at, I'm going to make a decision where I know both people, and one person is going to be upset obviously and the other's not," said Portuondo, already a familiar face across the industry. "At the end of the day, I look at it like this: That's what we're getting paid to do and we're making that decision on what we're seeing."

No one gets preferential treatment.

"For me, I look at it from a betting perspective: I used to be a bettor myself, so I know what bettors are looking for," said the AGCO associate judge, who was training at Woodbine Racetrack on Sunday. "I know it's frustrating when the inquiry sign goes up and you're just, 'Make a decision!' Now that I'm on the other side, I see why it takes us [judges] time, because we're looking at the video; we're speaking with the drivers, the riders involved, so there's a lot to process."

Speed is critical, but not at the expense of coming to the best decision in the moment. "It's not just about making that decision right away," said Portuondo. "We've got to get all the information together, and there are three of us [judges] up there [in the stand]. It's an odd number so that when we make a decision, we don't have an even number." In his view, taking more time isn't just annoying to the betting public; it doesn't translate into greater accuracy, either: "The way I see it, if you're taking that long to make a decision, you're not 100 per cent sure."

There's no regular day on the job. The Mississauga, ON native travels around the province to racetracks and rolls with what's happening that day. There's little "show prep" in his new role.

"Basically, our job is in the stand," he said. "We get to the racetrack about two and a half, three hours, maybe three and a half – it depends on the racetrack – before the races start. We're back there in the office, in case anybody has licensing problems; any issues with the horses and they want to come in to talk about equipment changes; they have to come in for a review; they want to call in and scratch the horses because of weather – we're there for various reasons. So it's not just about being in the stand. We're at the actual racetrack beforehand to settle different matters; you know, a couple of people that were fighting in the shedrow, and stuff like that."

During the card, Portuondo and colleagues stay focused.

"Once races start, we're strictly up in the stand," he said. "We're watching the races; we're watching replays; we're adjudicating; we're making decisions; we're looking at the 'splash', which is basically the finish of every horse, to make sure that if there's a photo, we agree that the #3 was ahead of the #4 or it's a dead heat. There's a lot going on, even in



between races, like putting horses on the judges' list, putting them on the vet's list, or calling the trainers, letting them know that their horse needs to qualify because of consecutive breaks on a fast track. We're dealing with claims: we're making sure claims are good; we're letting them know who the winning claimant is."

It's not for everyone.

"A lot of people were like, 'Why do you want to do this job?" said the former racing analyst and handicapper. "People are going to yell at me. That's okay, because most jobs, you have to report to a higher authority. That's just the way it is right now. The thing is, when we [judges] make a decision, everybody knows about it, and regardless of which way we go, somebody's not going to like it. So if you're that person that's going to want everyone on your side and don't have anyone mad at you-forget it."

Portuondo said he would like to see enhanced communication of regulatory decisions in the future.

"You know, there are ideas that I have, but me being the newbie, I don't want to come in guns blazing and try to rewrite the books and change the world," he said. "I know we're not at that point yet, but I think if we can get to the point where maybe we can explain the reason why we made the decision we made, it can help the bettor understand, from their point of view. We're not there yet, but that's something that may happen down the line."

Playing favorites is no longer an option for Portuondo, although he has a few personal ones, like the horses he considers most impressive.

"On the thoroughbred side I would say Ghostzapper. On the harness side, I'd go with Cam Fella, just because growing up, he was the horse that kind of put racing on the map for me. Then I became friends with Norm Clements, and he was able to get me a video of Cam Fella."


A highlight from his time on the Woodbine media team is harder to single out.

"That's tough!" he said, laughing. "I've got so many of them... I guess it would have been the Breeders Crown at Woodbine, when I got to work with 'Hollywood' Heyden. That was pretty cool because I had met a lot of great figures in racing, and he was definitely one of them and a treat to work with."

Those who miss his presence on the Woodbine Mohawk Park simulcast can still catch "Porty" alongside his friend, Canadian Olympic champion sprinter Donovan Bailey, on their podcast, "Running Things." Horse racing talk is mostly off-limits, except for lighter themes.

"He's learning from me. He told me he thinks he's faster than a horse, but he's not," said Portuondo. "We're trying to get him into some new things, and I've got to get him behind a horse one day. He's too big to sit on one, but he's not too big to sit behind one, so that's the goal."

This past Saturday when I was watching the major stakes from Dayton I saw something that I never thought I would see again. The last race featuring Bulldog Hanover was going to post close to midnight and the apron was packed with customers who probably had stayed around for almost five hours waiting to see Bulldog Hanover race.

Ordinarily at the Meadowlands by the last race the place is empty and even when we hosted the Breeders Crown I doubt if we had as many people on the apron as they had around midnight.

What this tells me is that our customers want to see great horses which is the reason for the Gural Rule. The only people, in my mind, that are effected are the four people who may own one of the top 3-year-olds who have to wait a year to syndicate them and maybe the four people who own the major breeding farms who have to wait a year as well.

To argue that the Gural Rule is not good for the sport is ridiculous. We saw exactly what happens when a great horse races even at a secondary facility like Dayton. For those of you who are young and working in the industry I hope you will remember that I tried my best to give you a future as any form of entertainment — be it sports, horse racing, movies or theater requires stars in order to attract customers. That was the whole purpose of the Gural Rule. Fortunately, Bulldog Hanover has come along to prove it.

It's too bad I could not get the Hambletonian Society and WEG to stick with it but I think that they are heavily influenced by a handful of breeders who, as I said, are probably negatively impacted. Hopefully Bulldog Hanover can stay sound and can race at the Meadowlands in the TVG in November.



As the field hit the three-quarter pole in 1:24.1, Sea Silk began to open up and cruised to victory in 1::52.4.

Do It Like Bobbie was second with Twenty finishing third.

The win made Sea Silk a millionaire as she has now earned \$1,005,154 in her 16 career victories.

The daughter of Downbytheseaside is trained by Burke and owned by the Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi, Knox Services, and Hatfield Stables. She was bred by Steiner Stock Farm.

The first of the three titles for Page and Burke came in the 2-year-old filly pacing division when **McSeaside** rallied down the stretch to win by two-lengths in 1:53.4.

Aaron Merriman took More The Merrier to the early lead and tried to race away from the field with fractions of :26.3, :54.2, and 1:22.4 opening up a seven-length lead. As More The Merrier was running out of steam, Page took McSeaside, the even money favorite, three-wide around the final turn catching the leader mid-stretch.

Cruise Alert was second in a photo with More The Merrier hanging on for third.

The Downbytheseaside filly claimed her second win of the year and raised her earnings to \$220,114. McSeaside is owned by the Burke Racing Stable, Beasty LLC, J&T Silva Stables, and Knox Services, and was bred by Andray Farm and Sergent Stables.

Surfside Beach finished second but was placed eighth when it was ruled he went inside the pylons entering the passing lane. Downrightdelicious was elevated to second with Racing Rampage third.

Trained by Christi Noble and owned by Dennis Owens, Norman Rae Racing and James Morris, the son of McArdle won for the second time this year and raised his earnings to \$296,153. Rockmelikeyameanit was bred by GBW Breeding Farms.

In the 3-year-old colt trot, **Caviar Gold** and Aaron Merriman went to the lead through the first three quarters in :27.3, :56.4 and 1:54.2 before Longshot and Chris Lems challenged around the final turn.

"We were able to get a little bit of a breather, :55 and change half," said MacDonell. "You know he's always pacing strong to the wire which helps. When he got halfway down the lane, I knew he'd be pretty tough to get by."

Chuck Hanover has made \$141,682 in his sophomore campaign for owners Glb Stable of Lakeview, N.S. He paid \$16.70 for the win.

The female Grassroots Championship for sophomore pacers went in race six and Fade Out was sent off as the 3-2 favorite leaving from post six.

Doug McNair was behind the Sportswriter filly trained by his dad Gregg.

After sitting back from a :25.4 opening quarter set by Scott Young and Quebecoise and Austin Sorrie and Girl Scout Cookie, McNair sent his charge past both as the field entered the backstretch and made the lead.

"Austin and Scottie went out of there and took a shot," said McNair "I figured one of them or two of them would be waiting on me, and they were, and it kind of worked out."

Fade Out led field through second and third panels in :54.2, and 1:22.2 and McNair's filly was game in the lane as she held off a stretch drive from Semi-Final winner Raptors Won.

"You can't drive her like that every week," said McNair "She'd get tired on you sometimes, but it worked out tonight.

McNair and his dad have teamed up for plenty of OSS wins this season and will be looking to repeat their success in two weeks at the Oct. 15 Super Final back at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

It's always fun to win this race, or any race, but working for my dad it's even more special," said McNair. He's a lot less hard on me the next day."



THONG CONTROL UPSETS IN GRASSROOTS CHAMPIONSHIP FOR FRESHMAN PACERS

The \$60,000 Ontario Sires Stakes Grassroots Championship for 2-year-old male pacers saw 1-5 favorite Reign Supreme make front before the first turn, but 36-1 longshot **Thong Control** and Sylvain Filion stole the crown in deep stretch.

In a little early drama that foreshadowed a stunning stretch drive, James MacDonald lost Hes a Sweetheart to a break soon after the start. Reign Supreme, with Louis-Philippe Roy driving, cleared Watch My Chips and Doug McNair on the first turn, and The Golden Jet and Jody Jamieson followed from third to the :26 first quarter.

Roy's popular pacesetter led to the :55.2 half, shadowed by Watch My Chips and The Golden Jet, but there was plenty of action underway in the backfield.

Longshot Twin B Risenshine, and Travis Henry sat fourth; Ahi Sunshine and Bob McClure ventured first-over from fifth, with Chris Christoforou following with Watchmaker on cover second over.

Although Reign Supreme had opened up by three lengths going into the turn for home, he found himself matching strides with challenger Ahi Sunshine by three-quarters, which they reached together in 1:23.4.

Watchmaker looked ready to overtake both as the finish loomed, yet it was another closer who was gaining late ground, winding up from far back in eighth: Thong Control.

The Golden Jet surged between Reign Supreme and Ahi Sunshine strides from the wire, but Thong Control flew home out wide to win by a half-length in 1:51.4. Ahi Sunshine finished third, just ahead of Watchmaker.

Filion described how his colt stepped up after finishing fifth in his Sept. 22 OSS Grassroots Semi-Final at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

"Last time out I had him revved up too much, and I think I shut his air off," said Filion. "So tonight, with the outside post, I kept him quiet, and I was just hoping for good fractions, and you know what? Mother luck was with us tonight and he closed hard."

Although overlooked at the betting windows, Filion said he felt Thong Control just needed a reasonable trip to succeed in the Oct. 1 final.

"He raced good all year, maybe last week he was a bit deceiving, but he bounced back pretty good," said Filion. "When I was on [driver Scott Young's] back and he wanted to run over 'I felt I had a good shot there. When I moved him, he went hard and he raced real good."

Thong Control (Control The Moment–Thong Song) returned \$75.90 to win.

He is owned by Steve Garceau and Roland Trudel, Becancour, QC, and trainer Jean Tourigny, Guelph, ON, who recently went over the \$10-million mark in career earnings.

The 1:51.4 win is a new mark for the former \$15,000 Harrisburg yearling, who is the ninth foal of dam Thong Song. Bred by Douglas Millard, Woodstock, ON, the black colt is looked after by caretaker Kenny Ellis.

Grandeur Seelster fires early and often in Grassroots Championship win

Woodbine Mohawk Park announcer Ken Middleton called **Grandeur Seelster's** opening panel a "first quarter smoke show" in the \$60,000 Ontario Sires Stakes Grassroots Final for 2-year-old pacing fillies.

In the winner's circle afterward, driver Austin Sorrie agreed the pace was a little hot in the early going:

"I thought I was going to be in trouble at the quarter pole," said Sorrie.

But it was no trouble for fast-leaving Grandeur Seelster, who set a brisk pace in a :25.4 opening panel, with 61-1 Bettors Punch and Jonathan Drury pressing from the outside early, then settling in the pocket on the first turn.



The fillies raced single file to the :54.3 half, with the 4-5 favorite confidently maintaining her short lead for Sorrie.

Cheese So Pretty and James MacDonald tipped from third to move first-over on the final turn, with Twin Delight and Bob McClure following her cover second-over from fourth.

Grandeur Seelster kept two lengths ahead of their best efforts, reaching three-quarters in 1:23.1 under minimal urging from Sorrie, who glanced back several times during the stretch drive. He had put the whip away entirely as the gate-to-wire leader stopped the clock in 1:51.1, a new lifetime best.

In the battle for place, three-wide Twin Delight pulled ahead of ground-saving closer Shake It Twice and Doug McNair and Bettors Punch, who held on for fourth.

"She was good last week, so I just hoped she was good this week," said Sorrie after the win. "Starting out, she was real green, so it helped a lot driving her all summer. When she got real good, you knew when she was good."

Grandeur Seelster was the only female OSS Grassroots Semifinals winner to repeat in the Oct. 1 finals.

"If she's as good as she was there, next year, she'll be a good Gold filly," said Sorrie.

Grandeur Seelster paid \$3.60 to win in her fourth seasonal victory from eight starts.

Owned by Gestion Mastel Inc., Courtney Gallant, and trainer Marcel Barrieau the daughter of All Bets Off-Glamour Seelster was bred by Seelster Farms of Lucan, ON.

Caretaker Cindy Rapson looks after the former \$37,000 yearling, purchased at the 2021 London Select Sale.

One had a textbook pocket trip while the other was parked just about every step of the mile tonight at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Stormont Mabel was victorious in the filly's test, a nine horse affair in race one with the scratch of Ladyflix.

Rose Run Xcentric, with Trevor Henry at the lines, grabbed the early lead and led the field by the opening quarter in :27. She remained in control past the :56.1 half with the rest of the fillies in single file behind her. That formation didn't last.

Harness Racing Update

Longshot (36-1) Saint Antoine with Scott Young in the bike, popped out from third and was closing in on the leader at the 1:25.1 third panel.

Saint Antoine took the lead in mid-stretch but was caught in the final steps by Stormont Mabel who reached the wire with a neck advantage in a new lifetime mark of 1:53.3 after Louis-Philippe Roy engineered the perfect pocket trip for the Garry Werner trainee.

"That's a good record for her, so we are very happy with how she performed tonight," said Werner. "It worked out well, she got a perfect trip, and Louis had a phenomenal drive. He just sat in the two hole with her and never really had to do a whole lot of the hard work until halfway down the lane."

The top three finishers were all sired by the late Kadabra as Saint Antoine was second and Hershey Seelster grabbed the show spot. The favorite Hang On Baby and Muscle Up The Gold took the last two cheques.

This was the first start for Stormont Mabel with Merner listed as trainer. Desiree Jones was the filly's trainer of record for all of her prior starts and Merner was quick to credit Jones and explain the conditioner change.

"I was very happy with how she raced, but to be honest with you I can't really take any credit for that mare," said Merner. "Desiree Jones trained her down at two and three and brought this filly along. Desiree went to Lexington early last week to focus on yearlings, so she asked me if I'd take her and train her for the week, and that's pretty much all I can take credit for. All I did was get her to the track."

A homebred for Stormont Meadows of Long Sault, ON, Stormont Mabel improved her 2022 record to 3-4-3 in 16 tries for \$77,000 in earnings. Tonight's effort shaved a full three seconds off her previous best time. Mabel finished ninth in the Grassroots point standings and paid \$18.70 to win.

"We are just happy with the way everything went, and the connections seemed like they were pretty happy, so it's been a successful night," concluded Merner.

Eric Baker's Stormont Meadows' raised colts and fillies have raced in the OSS for many years. They also had another starter in this contest, Mabel's former stablemate Stormont Molly who was the leading point earner in this Grassroots division, but she wound up eighth in the final.

Roy drove Stormont Mabel earlier this summer, including in her only other OSS victory this year, at Mohawk in early June. He was impressed by how she'd improved since the last time he sat behind her.

"I think the connections did a pretty good job getting her ready for tonight. Sometimes she would need a little more down the stretch, and she wasn't giving you what she gave me today. I just told Gary, she just found another gear in the stretch that she didn't used to have. I was impressed and happy with her," he praised.

As for the trip he noted: "When I got her on Youngy's helmet she just found another gear, and from there I was confident that she was going to go by. That's a big mile, the track crew have been doing a good job, the track is very nice tonight."

Stormont Mabel is the second foal of Tamasin Hall, who earned just over \$100,000 in her career. Her first foal, AP Hall Of Trix, a winner of \$150,000+ to date in his career, also raced today, finishing fourth at Pocono. Her immediate family includes many top OSS trotters including Hall of Famer Bridger, along with Mombasa, and Brisco Herbert.

The colts' contest, race eight, saw favorite Warrawee Xalt make a break in the first turn to take himself out of contention while **Resolute Bay**, with James MacDonald at the controls, overcame just seeing the rail for a couple of seconds in the race to win impressively.

As the wings folded many of the sophomores were vying for the lead and Sylvain Filion had Renegade Gypsy in that position at the first quarter in :26.4.

Radio Lab and Ed Hensley took over the front well before the :55.4 half but Renegade Gypsy retook before the 1:25.4 three-quarters.

Down the stretch though it was Resolute Bay with the most trot and he won going away in 1:54.1 despite the trip. Archery Seelster, Renegade Gypsy, Kipper Whipr Snipr and Ima Standup Guy were next across.

"It's hard to jostle for position, especially from the outside," explained MacDonald. "He got out of there good but everybody was leaving and there was nothing to be had. I was three wide past the quarter, I got in for a step but I had to go again. I said, 'well maybe he'll get some money but there's no way he can win off this trip.' He came off the turn and just blew by. He's really racing so good right now hopefully he stays with this form."

It was the fifth straight win for the striking chestnut gelding owned by The Stable Resolute Bay and trained by Harry Poulton. A son of Resolve, Resolute Bay upped his lifetime bankroll over \$110,000 with tonight's victory.

"Early in the year he showed flashes of quick speed but not the durability," said MacDonald. "The last two weeks, it's been scary big miles and still going forward at the wire, I couldn't believe the mile he went tonight."

MacDonald's brother Anthony and his wife Amy operate TheStable.ca which is enjoying a great year.

"It's a really good barn and good group of owners, fortunately for me that means a lot of nice horses to drive. Anthony and Amy have done a terrific job," said MacDonald. "Everyone who works for The Stable works hard and puts the hours in and the results are showing on the track,"

It was MacDonald's second Grassroots Final win of the night for the barn having won earlier on the card with Nothingbutadreamer also trained by Poulton.

No Angel Like Me saved her best for last, getting up in the final strides to take the \$60,000 Ontario Sires Stakes Grassroots Final for 2-year-old trotting fillies, Saturday at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

After hitting the podium in her first four starts, including a pair of seconds, No Angel Like Me, trained by Kelly Duval Lacaille and driven by her father Sylvain Lacaille, struck Grassroots gold courtesy of a gritty score.

It was 4-5 choice Lucy Who, in rein to Trevor Henry, who got away quickest of all off the gate, as the bay filly, on a four-race win streak, took command into the first turn, with No Angel Like Me settling into second spot and Enola tucking in third.

Ahead by two lengths at the quarter in :28.4, Lucy Who and Henry then slowed the pace down, cutting a half in 1:00.1, as No Angel Like Me continued to track the pacesetter, with Enola maintaining her third-place position and Sweet Carrie T inheriting fourth spot after Angelic Kt broke stride.

Still in control after three-quarters in 1:30, Lucy Who looked to trot away from her rivals down the lane, but a persistent No Angel Like Me kept grinding away to the outside of her rival.

With the finish line drawing closer, Lacaille urged his brown filly for her best and she responded, eking out a head triumph in a career-best 1:58.2. Enola took third and 103-1 St Lads Tricky was elevated from fifth to fourth, after Cunning Connie was placed last after an extended break.

"Winning is so exciting, it's a dream come true," said Duval Lacaille. "Working hard for so many years, and trying to get somewhere, for me it's everything winning that race. She raced awesome. She always showed that she can do her job easily and she just made it today. I am not surprised she ended up as a winner tonight. To do it with my dad is super awesome. It's the most beautiful feeling because it's family, and nothing is better than family."

A daughter of Archangel—BistroBistro Taj, bred and owned by Candice Morel, No Angel Like Me arrived at the final off a third-place finish, albeit only a head back of the winner, in her Grassroots elim on Sept. 22.

She launched her career with a third-place effort in a Grassroots leg at Dresden on Aug. 1, followed by a second at Kawartha Downs, also in Grassroots action, 12 days later.

On Saturday night under the lights on the big stage, she notched her milestone tally in style.

"The horse has always been great," beamed Duval Lacaille. "She has been good since day one, and she will still be good. She made her job like she did since the first day."

No Angel Like Me paid \$13.70 for the win.

A Grassroots 'Dreamer' come true

Nothingbutadreamer made a return to the winner's circle on Saturday night (Oct. 1) at Woodbine Mohawk Park, fending off a determined foe to take top prize in the \$60,000 Ontario Sires Stakes Grassroots Final for two-year-old trotting colts and geldings.

The bay son of Muscle Mass—Myimpossibledream came into his latest engagement having gone winless in his past four starts.

On this evening, the colt, trained by Harry Poulton for The Stable. ca's Nothinbutadreamr group, was picture perfect.

All Star Yankee crossed over from post nine to make the front into the first turn and led by a length after an opening panel carved out in :27.3, as Rough Tuff Tested followed in second with Nothingbutadreamer in third.

There was plenty of action in the backstretch as Rough Tuff Tested, with Doug McNair driving, wrested the lead away from All Star Yankee, only to have Nothingbutadreamer quickly overtake him for top spot, then hold a 1 ½-length advantage through a half in :56.4.

What was shaping up to be a two-horse race quickly became a reality after three-quarters in 1:26.1, as Nothingbutadreamer, to the inside, and Rough Tuff Tested slugged it out down the lane, before the former took control, en route to a one-length score in a time of 1:55.2.

A game Rough Tuff Tested was well ahead of Take On Me for the runner-up spot. Busting With Pride was fourth.

"He was trotting good tonight. Doug's [horse] sounded really live on my back, and when he was shouting in the turn, I was worried," said winning driver James MacDonald, whose brother Anthony heads the fractional ownership group TheStable.ca "But 'Dreamer' gives you everything he's got, and he wants to win. That's a big component of being a good horse and he's turned into a really nice horse."

After a fifth to start his career on June 20 at Woodbine Mohawk Park, Nothingbutadreamer broke stride in his next dash.

The third time, however, was the charm as the bay colt, bred by Shmuel Farhi, recorded his first victory, an authoritative 4 ¾-length triumph in 1:58.2 Grassroots leg at the Milton oval on July 19.

With the win, Nothingbutadreamer has fashioned a 4-1-1 mark from 10 starts, accompanied by over \$80,000 in purse earnings.

"It's great to see a big crowd in the winner's circle for 'Dreamer' there, and that's hats off to my brother Anthony and TheStable for the crowd they bring every night," said MacDonald.

Wolverina, Treacherous Tom continue to roll in MASS stakes

The second division of 3-year-old eligibles of the \$2.5 million (est.) Massachusetts Sire Stakes convened at Plainridge Park on Sunday (Oct. 2) with four races going for \$65,000 each and some winning horses came to play.

In the pacing filly division, **Wolverina** (Cheyenne Hollywood—Terri I Fra) won her second straight MASS engagement of 2022 by taking advantage of a perfect drive.

Nick Graffam tucked Wolverina second in behind Dude's Sweet Bet (John Macdonald) who set a pace of :26.4,:55.4 and 1:23.3 with the field of nine stretched out by 13 lengths. Wolverina continued to follow Dude's Sweet Bet until midway through the last turn when Graffam tipped along with Shakeitoffscarlet (Kevin Switzer Jr.) and both engaged Dude's Sweet Bet. The three fillies were almost even across the track all the way down to the wire where Wolverina got the clear advantage by one-half length and won in a new lifetime mark of 1:53.2.

It was the 10th straight win for Wolverina (\$6.40) who hasn't tasted defeat in 3-1/2 months going back to June 19. Wolverina was bred and is owned by her trainer Mike Graffam, in partnership with William Arnold.

Another streaking horse is **Treacherous Tom** (Captaintreacherous—Kate Is Well Said) who easily handled the boys in the male pacing division.

Treacherous Tom (Bruce Ranger) went right to the front and took total control of the race. He set solid fractions of :27, :56 and 1:25 while the remainder of the field tried to keep pace. Heading for home, Treacherous Tom stretched out to an easy 2-½ length lead and cruised to victory over Use Yah Blinkah (Jim Hardy) and Striking Impact (Drew Monti) in 1:53.2.

It was the third straight win and eighth of the year in only 10 starts for Treacherous Tom (\$2.20) who is owned by Tom and Scott Dillon and trained by Joe Nelson. Fashion Farms bred the winner.

Both trotting winners were piloted by Yannick Gingras who is again the leading driver in this year's series.

In the trotting filly division, Gingras piloted **Dancin On The Wall** (Walner—Lovely Lindy) to victory in a solid bounce-back after she made an uncharacteristic break last week.

Tennessee Lindy (Nick Graffam) led at the quarter in :28.1 when Dancin On The Wall made a brush for the front. She got there in easy fashion and then dominated the rest of the way. With no threats coming from behind, Dancin On The Wall hit three-quarters in 1:26.4, rounded the last turn and simply trotted away from the field by three lengths in 1:56.1.

Dancin On The Wall (\$2.40) got her third win of the year for breeder/owner K R Breeding. Domenico Cecere trains the winner.

Gingras followed that up with a win behind last year's 2-yearold male trotting champion **Bill Bauer** (E L Titan-Miss Flaggy Meadow) who took his first step towards defending his title today.

Moni's Heaven Sent (Jay Randall) sat on the lead early, but Bill Bauer took the lead in front of the stands and crossed over to the pylons by the half and from there, he won in hand. After passing three-quarters on top by 1-½ lengths, he rounded the turn and trotted home by the same margin in 1:56.3 under a line drive from Gingras.

Bill Bauer (\$2.80) got his second win of the year for his trainer Paul Kelley, who co-owns the trotter with Joe Palillo and Ellen Palillo. East Pond Stable was the breeder.

New Jersey Classic Series will return in 2023

The Meadowlands and the Standardbred Breeders & Owners Association of New Jersey (SBOANJ) are announcing that the New Jersey Classic Series (NJCS) will return in 2023.

The NJCS was designed to offer the connections of New Jersey-sired horses another option to race their 2 & 3-year-olds for big purses in the state. Total purses for the 2022 races were over \$2 million and are expected to be similar next year.

Looking ahead to 2023, changes to the format to encourage fuller fields are being discussed. Also, in 2023, the NJCS will be adjusted to include horses eligible for the NJ Standardbred Development Fund races along with NJ Sired. Adding the SDF horses will provide a welcome earning opportunity for the foals of mares that are housed within the state of New Jersey, whether sired by a stallion standing in NJ or not. The inclusion of the SDF horses will also provide a larger pool of horses eligible for nomination.

(Eligibility for the Standardbred Development Fund series will be open to all horses sired by New Jersey-based stallions as well as horses that are the result of a breeding between any registered standardbred stallion and a standardbred mare that has spent a minimum of 150 consecutive days in New Jersey inclusive of foaling)

The intention for the 2-year-old New Jersey Sires Stakes at The Meadowlands next year is to begin those stakes two weeks later to allow Jersey bred colts and fillies additional time to prepare.

Further information on scheduling for the stakes will be made available as soon as the date application process is completed later this month.
