Lexington sale sets slew of new records through two days, tops \$43 million

The second session of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale saw new record highs for session gross (over \$20 million), average (over \$90,000) and six-figure yearlings (75) and established new standards for gross (over \$43.5 million), average (over \$124,000) and \$100,000+ yearlings (164) through two days.



The Lexington Selected Yearling Sale remained red hot through its second session held Tuesday (Oct. 4) at the Fasig-Tipton sales pavilion.

The sale set new records for second-session gross (\$20,433,000), average (\$90,013) and six-figure yearlings (75) and has also established new two-day standards for gross (\$43,500,000), average (\$124,642) and \$100,000+ yearlings (164).



Steve and Cindy Stewart of Hunterton Farm have sold the top two horses, three of the top four and the session two sale topper and are only \$1,000 behind Preferred Equine for leading consignor by gross sales through two days.

The second-session median of \$75,000 tied the record set during the second session of the 2018 sale.

The second session was **up 14 per cent in gross** and **up 7 per cent in average** compared to the second night of the sale in 2021. **Through two nights, the sale is up 19 per cent in gross** and **up 12 per cent in average** compared to a year ago.

This year 227 yearlings were sold in session two compared to 213 a year ago.

"Through two sessions, the gross is \$43 million and we've sold 164 for more than \$100,000. Last year, it was 159 for the whole sale," said the sale's co-manager David Reid. "It's very simple, in my opinion. I haven't looked at the breakdown numbers, but I'm sure it's attributed to the sire power that we have, the pedigrees of the mares and the performance.

"(Tuesday's) session we obviously added some horses. We started an hour earlier and ended a little late. That's something I think that (co-manager) Randy (Manges) and myself will address for next year, but the crowd did stay right here until the end. The end of the session was strong and it was another outstanding session, for sure.

"The proof was in the pudding. The sale was great. The numbers indicate that it was great. It's a good thing to have a lot of quality horses. Part of the planning, when Randy and myself go through and talk to the consignors... it's a great problem to have. It validates our position by having the quality and the numbers."

SESSION TOPPER HITS \$500,000

The session topper was **Hip 197 Flashback Bi**, a Greenshoe colt out of Dream Child that sold to Courant Inc. out of the Hunterton consignment for \$500,000.

Sabine Kagebrandt, CEO for Courant Inc. said, "I loved all the four horses that we bought from Greenshoe. I loved them because they have so much of Greenshoe in them," Kagebrandt said. "They have flawless conformation. They are very athletic and they are good technicians... very good. They are well balanced and I like that they have a good mindset."

Hunterton also sold the two highest-priced yearlings on opening night — Hip 57 Epoch (f, Chapter Seven—Jolene Jolene) for \$725,000 and Hip 70 Vic Zelenskyy (c Greenshoe—Mission Brief) for \$550,000— and three of the top four, including Hip 63 Awaiting (f, Walner—Lonely Lady) for \$525,000.

"It's rewarding," said Hunterton's Steve Stewart. "People look at it and think that it just happens, but it doesn't. There's a lot of work involved... Forty years. After many years, you get better at it, I quess.

"The one thing that helps us a lot, as I've said in the past, is that a lot of the horses we've sold have raced very well – the expensive ones. That give a lot of confidence. As an example, last night Lovely Lady's filly brings \$525,000. She was bought by Ken Jacobs because he spent \$510,000 last year on the full sister and they look very similar and she made \$300,000 this year. They are coming back and that's the most rewarding for us.

"We're well-aware how important the sale prices are, but it's even more rewarding when a good horse that we sell races. That's the biggest reward for us."

Through two days, Hunterton is neck-and-neck with Preferred Equine for the leading consignor title by gross. Preferred leads with \$7,549,000. Hunterton has grossed 7,548,000.

"Success begets success. It's the same thing if you're a trainer. If you do really well and you've got a lot of good horses, guess what? People are going to send you more horses," Stewart said. "So, our reputation of selling horses that race and do well comes back and rewards you. It's the same thing if you're a stallion. If you're a stallion and you produce a lot of good horses... it kind of makes sense, but it's still very rewarding. We do not take it for granted."

Hip 200 Eunoia Hanover, a Captaintreacherous filly out of Eloquent Grace, posted the second-highest price of the second session. She was sold for \$375,000 to Nancy Takter, agent for Caviart Farms, from the Hanover Shoe Farms consignment.

Through two days, Hanover leads all consignors in average with \$194,174 for 23 yearlings.

ALAGNA LEADS BUYERS

Through the first two sessions, trainer Tony Alagna has spent the most. He's paid \$2,469,000, total, to take home 15 yearlings -\$1,485,000 to get eight yearlings on day one and \$984,000 on day two for seven horses.



Trainer Marcus Melander, agent, is next with \$1,910,000 all spent on day one on eight yearlings.

Doug Overhiser is third with \$1,883,000 spent on 14 yearlings — six for \$1,082,000 on day one and eight for \$801,000 on day two.

"There's a little bit of science to it," Overhiser said. "I try to do a little bit of analytics, but last year I concentrated very heavily on pacers and very few trotters. This year, coming in, we're going to heavy trotters and a little lighter on the pacers. It works out nice, right, because all those are moving to 3 and now these are 2.

"Last year, we bought 16 and I think my average price was \$60,000. I think I raised my hand a lot, just because I liked it. It was my first year really doing it. I listened to Erv (Miller), most of the time, but some of the time I went off on my own and that didn't work, so this year it was like, 'This is what we did, here were some of the mistakes...' I said it last year, but really this year I really let Erv drive it. Now, he's conservative when it comes to the money. Sometimes, he stops and it's just crazy to keep spending and then I (keep going) because if I don't, then he won't."

FILLIES STILL RULE, WALNER TAKES OVER

Through two sessions, fillies are averaging the most. Trotting fillies lead with an average of \$135,735, followed by pacing fillies (\$132,320), trotting colts (\$118,566) and pacing (\$115,097).

Whereas Greenshoe led all stallions in gross through day one, Walner is now the leading sire through two sessions

(\$6,467,000), followed by Captaintreacherous (\$5,954,000) and Greenshoe (\$5,738,000) and Chapter Seven (\$5,724,000).

ONLINE BIDDING

As for online bidding, the Proxibid platform sold zero horses on opening night. On Tuesday, four were sold online for a total of \$282,000. Online bidders were the underbidders on eight yearlings on night two. Over two days Proxibid has taken 141 bids -20 on day one and 121 on day two.

"I think in the next few days you're going to see people bidding remotely that have friends or colleagues look at horses here on their behalf," Reid said. "I think our Proxibid sign-ups today are better than yesterday. When you're dealing with more expensive yearlings, part of the buyer's process really does involve being on the grounds. They want to be here and see the horses and put partnerships together. They are trying to figure out what other guys are doing and the gamesmanship that goes into it all."

Today's (Oct. 5) third session of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale will feature some 237 yearlings. It begins today at 2 p.m. at Fasig-Tipton. For more information about the sale, please visit: www.lexingtonselected.com








The sweet farewell

With three races left before she is retired, superstar trotting mare Atlanta was soaking up the attention as she was feted Tuesday at Fasig-Tipton.

Awash in soothing Lexington autumn sunshine, the incomparable Atlanta was greeting well-wishers Tuesday morning on the backside of the Crawford Farms shedrow at Fasig-Tipton with the air of class befitting a Hambletonian-winning queen. The look in her eye suggested the intense gameness that was the hallmark of a career that has earned over \$3.4 million and counting.

Trainer Jimmy Takter — who, along with his daughter, Nancy, campaigned Atlanta's chief rival, Manchego — came to pay his respects at the latest of several farewell parties Atlanta's partowner Michelle Crawford is throwing in the trotter's honor as she winds down her racing career.

"That mare cost me a lot of money," Takter said with reverence. Brad Grant, who owns Atlanta with Crawford and Howard Taylor, smiled.

"For the man that's king of the sport to come over and look at a 7-year-old mare when he's here to look at yearlings, it shows respect, but it also shows what she's earned," Grant said.

Mickey Burke Jr. from the Ron Burke Racing team that campaigned Atlanta at ages 4 through 7 was also watching. Asked to pinpoint Atlanta's defining characteristic, Burke didn't hesitate.

"Determination," Mickey said.

"Jimmy Takter was just standing here saying, 'She's not always the greatest gaited or anything, but she just doesn't want to lose.' She just loves to go and she's game."

The daughter of Chapter Seven—Hemi Blue Chip was originally picked out and purchased by trainer Rick Zeron from the 2016 Standardbred Horse Sales Company yearling auction in Harrisburg, PA for \$60,000. Zeron campaigned Atlanta to a 2018 Hambletonian victory and earnings exceeding \$1.1 million at ages 2 and 3 before the trotter was sold to dissolve a partnership at the end of her sophomore year and placed in the care of the Burke Brigade.

Atlanta has added some \$2.1 million to her earnings in the four years since.

"I think you guys had the bigger chore, because she was already there and you kept her there for years," Grant said to Mickey. "To keep any horse at that top end of their game like that, Ronnie was taking a challenge on, because she was the best when he got her and he's kept her there."

But soon, that part of Atlanta's career will come to an end — as evidenced by her being feted with Bloody Mary toasts at Fasig-Tipton.

"People are thanking us for bringing her so that they can see a true champion. Look at her, she's just stunning and she knows

it. She's just special and... I get so much happiness when other people love on her," Crawford said.

Atlanta has just three races left — the Allerage this Sunday (Oct. 9) at Red Mile, the Breeders Crown at the end of October at Woodbine Mohawk Park and then the TVG at The Meadowlands — before she becomes a full-time broodmare at Crawford Farms. Atlanta already has a Muscle Hill weanling filly on the ground produced by embryo transfer.

"I think the sad part isn't that she's going on to a new career and greener pastures, as far as being a momma and broodmare... I think the saddest part in my stomach is that we're not going to see her on the racetrack anymore," Crawford said. "It's the staking, it's the racing, it's the 'Is she going to race against the boys or the girls?' There was so much that went into all of it and following her. I just couldn't wait for her first race of the year, every year, so I try not to think about it because it just makes me sad."

"This mare – year after year after year – she's ranked at the top of her game. She's going out on a high," Grant said. "She's where she belongs. Michelle has loved her since the day she joined the group. She said one day she'd have her as a broodmare and she's where she belongs. It ended up perfect. If you wrote a book, you wrote a happy ending," Grant said.

Add in Crawford's other Hambletonian-winning mare Ramona Hill (2020) and it makes for quite the pair for her broodmare band and quite the décor for Crawford's house.

"The pictures on the back wall over there, they are bookends in my house that big," Crawford said, pointing toward huge banners. "They are life size, nose-to-nose flanking my fireplace. Who gets to do that? Two Hambo-winning fillies within three years of each other."

Atlanta was also instrumental in bringing together Crawford, Grant and Taylor.

"We're working on our next partnership. Haven't found it yet, but we're working on it," Grant said. "In all the time the three of us have owned the horse, there's never been an issue."

"If two felt strongly, the other one just went with it," Crawford said. "We just worked it out. It's been fun and it's been easy and I want to do it again."





Christian Lind reflects on his career year and sustained growth

When it came to making a great first impression, Christian Lind absolutely nailed it. His lasting one is equally as impressive.

It was just over six years ago when the Swedish-born horseman sat in the sulky for his milestone first race, one that seemed anything but a sure thing.

Saddled with post nine and flashing odds of 15-1 on the tote board, a top-four finish would have been reason to celebrate.

Lind, however, had other plans, culminating in a trip to the winner's circle at Pocono Downs on July 19, 2016.

"I know that kind of thing doesn't happen very often, so it was a really nice way to start things off. When you see success like that right away, it makes it more fun and makes you want to pursue it even more," Lind said.

The victory was even more special considering Lind's father, Staffan, trained the daughter of Rock N Roll Heaven—Love of Art.

"That made the win that much better, to be able to share that with him."

If there had been any thought Lind was going to be a flash-inthe-pan, one-hit wonder type, he quickly showed he was quite the opposite.

In his rookie campaign, he went 5-5-1 from 36 starts. One year later, in 2017, he won 23 of 161 starts and recorded \$320,440 in purse earnings.

"The best thing my dad ever told me was to always look forward, which I tried to do from the very beginning of my career. From race to race, it's very easy to get caught up if you are having a bad day. It's better to take every race as it comes, make that the focus and then move on to the next one."

After seasons of 17,13 and 11 wins, Lind won 37 races in 2021. This year, he's in the midst of a banner campaign, one that has already yielded career-best numbers across the board.



Harness Racing Update

The recent results are a direct result of a shift in approach to his craft.

"I would say the last two years, I've definitely had more focus. I was driving pretty much everything for my dad, and I think I got a little too comfortable with that. With him moving back to Sweden, it changed my perspective, that I had to focus more and take it even more seriously. I think when I started to do that, I've seen a lot of growth in myself and my abilities on the track."

As for his best attribute in the sulky, Lind points to a patient hand and the ability to make split-second audibles.

"I'm not going to rush out and just see what happens. I prefer to put the horse where I think it should be and give it the best chance to win. Obviously, things can go the exact opposite of what you are anticipating, so you have to be able to adapt quickly too."

Keeping an open mind and an open ear has also served him well.

Lind has had the good fortune to have worked with some of the top names in the sport, including trainers and fellow Swedes, Nancy Takter and Marcus Melander, as well as conditioner John Hughes.

He's also had the opportunity to talk shop with top reinsman such as Grand Circuit stars Yannick Gingras and Andrew McCarthy, who have shared helpful advice and encouraging words.

All of what he's learned from those conversations and experiences have been a game-changer for Lind, who has transitioned from splitting time as a trainer and driver, to a nearly 100 per cent focus on the latter.

"I appreciate all of the advice I've received and I'm grateful for the chance I've had to be around so many successful people. That's been the best part, to have learned from people who are willing to take the time to answer questions and help give me confidence. You do pick up small things from everyone and you use that to hone your own skills."

Armed with a set gameplan and buoyed by a confident mindset, Lind has enjoyed recent success at Oak Grove in Kentucky.

Now, the New Jersey-based horseman is looking to expand his driving reach.

"Short term, I'm sticking around the Red Mile. I've been in Kentucky for the past five months. I've been thinking a lot of where I'm going to be, the best place for me. After that, I'm going to try and get in a little bit out east at The Meadowlands and Chester, to see if I can pick some drives up and make it a good winter. Long term, I'm going to ride this out and see where this all takes me."

If recent outcomes are any indication of how that will unfold, Lind should no doubt be optimistic.

The shift to a near full-time driving career has certainly paid its dividends.

"Driving, to me, is what attracts me to this sport. I love training down babies and fixing little things with the horses, but the adrenaline rush I get is when I'm driving. That's the reason for me to focus on it. That's the reason to get up every day and better myself."

Lind has also come to appreciate the benefits of enjoying life outside the sphere of racing.

Relaxation is found in the form of the great outdoors with his girlfriend and standardbred groom, Amalie Ødegård.

"We like to spend time together, including going on hikes, something to get away from the pressures of racing for a little while. If you didn't do something, your mind would easily be on the horses all time. To be able to spend time with her, and just relax is really helpful."

Another boost comes in the form of the support Lind receives from back home.

"That's the fun part about racing. You can have a really good day and when you see people's comments, it really makes you so happy. My mom always posts on Facebook when I win and then I get to read what people back in Sweden say. Sometimes you forget that there are so many people there who follow what you do, but when you see that, it reminds you of how lucky you are."









Star filly Righteous Resolves continues winning ways in final Gold leg

Super Bowl winning coach Bill Parcells famously said, "you are what your record says you are," and **Righteous Resolve's** record is screaming from the rooftops that she is the top 2-year-old trotting filly in Ontario.

Freshman trotters wrapped up their Ontario Sires Stakes Gold campaign Monday (Oct. 3) at Woodbine Mohawk Park, and the Resolve filly won a \$101,300 division to improve to 7-1-0 in 8 starts.

Four \$100,000-plus OSS divisions were on the card, two apiece for males and females, and the action got underway in race two with Righteous Resolve lining up against five challengers after Northern Charlotte was a late scratch.

Paul MacDonell wasted no time sending the heavily bet 1-9 favourite to the front from post seven and leading the field through an opening panel of :27.4. After the second panel went in :57.2, it was business as usual for the filly who eventually pulled away for the three-length score in 1:54.3.

"Paul does a great job with her," said assistant trainer Matt Bax. "I feel like he got a little bit of a breather to the half, and he just let her trot out, which she wanted to do, which later on in the next couple of starts that's going to go a long way to helping her."

A Bet Max Stables (Casco, MI) and Benenati Inc. (Clinton Township, MI) homebred, Righteous Resolve came into Monday riding a five-race win streak that included a win in the \$362,000 Peaceful Way final, and was capped by a sixlength score in the Champlain where she established a new stakes record of 1:53.1.

"I'd say she is very powerful and professional the way she handles herself," sad Bax. "With a 2-year-old filly that goes a long way."

The \$225,000 Ontario Sires Stakes Super Final on Oct. 15 at Woodbine Mohawk Park is up next for Righteous Resolve, and after that, a date with the Breeders' Crown on Oct. 28-29 at the Milton oval.

A pair of Muscle Mass fillies completed the trifecta. Mass Hysteria was second for trainer Kyle Bossence with Trevor Henry at the reins, and Louis Philippe-Roy drove Rob Fellows trainee Cardio Muscle to a third-place finish.



The middle two Ontario Sires Stakes divisions were upsets, with **Tuscan Prince** paying \$18.40 in the fourth race a \$103,100 division for colts and geldings, and **Shiny New Penny** breaking her maiden at 7-1 in race six, the other \$100,400 filly division.

Leaving from post eight Bob McClure held Tuscan Prince (Kadabra) off the pace established by Snowpiercer and Dws Point Man, who exchanged the lead through panels of :27.2, :57.1, and 1:26.1, and were dueling upfront as the field spun for home.

McClure found racing room four-wide down the stretch and the Luc Blais trainee trotted home in :27.3 to establish a new lifetime mark of 1:54.4 and earn his third OSS win this season, after a pair of Grassroots scores earlier in the campaign.

"He kind of forced them into putting him into the Golds he's raced so good," said McClure. "He's been well managed for sure, and I wouldn't want to have anything else going into the Super Final."

Shiny New Penny is from the first crop of Alarm Detector and is the freshman stallion's second winner.

Last time out the Jean Tournigy trainee made a misstep while battling the aforementioned Righteous Resolve on the lead and tonight Louis-Philippe Roy was careful leaving from the pylon post, sitting back in fourth through the :29.2 first panel.

Roy left on cover behind Its Your Choice and was out in front by the time the field passed the half in :58.2. His filly had plenty of trot left and she crossed the wire in front by length in a time of 1:56.2.

"I think I made a mistake trying to follow that good filly of Bax in her last start," said Roy. "We were going pretty fast there. Tonight, my plan was just to get her in good position, and I was pretty confident she would come out the best of it."

Santo Vena (Cedar Valley, ON), Nunzio Vena (Bolton, ON), and Diane Ingham (Mount Pleasant, ON) own Shiny New Penny who nearly tripled her earnings with the win to over \$84,000.


The final OSS race of the evening was race seven, and 8-5 favorite **Osceola** emerged victorious.

Driven and trained by Doug and Gregg McNair respectively, the Muscle Mass colt had an up and down summer, after impressing early on with a pair of back-to-back Gold wins.

He was on his game tonight, firing to the lead from post five and cutting the mile in 1:55.1 to win by a head over a late charging Hasty Bid.

"He's a little aggressive sometimes, and turns aren't his forte, but he's got a ton of trot and speed as you can see," said Doug. "I figured tonight in the five hole it's a real good spot to leave and get him slowed down by the turn and it worked out."

The win pushed him over \$160,000 in earnings for owners Gregg McNair (Guelph, ON) Willow Oak Ranch (Rogersville, TN), and Paul Hawman (Collingwood, ON).







Milliondollarwall, Rooster Bennett undefeated in MASS stakes

The \$2.5 Million (est.) Massachusetts Sire Stakes returned to Plainridge Park on Monday (Oct. 3) and featured the second round of 2-year-old contests with a total purse of \$260,000 up for grabs. There were a total of six races held with the colt trotters and filly pacers going one division for \$65,000 each and the colt pacers and filly trotters split into two divisions valued at \$32,500 each.

Starting with the trotting fillies, **Milliondollarwall** (Walner—Mom's Millionaire) remained undefeated lifetime after scoring her fourth win in four starts while claiming her second MASS victory.

Yannick Gingras gave Milliondollarwall the perfect pocket trip behind Get The Picture (Jay Randall) who led until the top of the stretch while setting even fractions. That's where Milliondollarwall made her move to the outside and trotted right by Get The Picture en route to a four length win in 1:57.1.

Milliondollarwall (\$2.10) was bred and is owned by Moni Maker Stable and is trained by Domenico Cecere.

The other division of female trotters went to **Laurens Hoopla** (E L Titan—Tattoo You) who more than made up for her miscue last week.

Nick Graffam sat third with Laurens Hoopla while the heavily favored Pembroke Moni (Yannick Gingras) got to the half in :58.4. Laurens Hoopla came first-over at that station for the outside grind that saw her draw alongside the leader heading into the stretch. After matching strides to the wire, Laurens Hoopla got the advantage over Pembroke Moni and won by one-half length in 1:56.2, which was a new lifetime mark and only one-fifth of a second off the stake record.

Laurens Hoopla (\$9.80) was bred and is owned by Ray Campbell Jr. and is trained by George Ducharme.

The pacing colts and geldings fastest division went to **Rooster Bennett** (So Surreal—Teddy Ballgirl) who also got his second MASS win and extended his personal win streak to four.

Luke McGook (Kevin Switzer Jr.) bolted to the front with Rooster Bennett (Yannick Gingras) on his back through quarters of :27.3,

:58.1 and 1:27.3. Gingras tipped Rooster Bennett in the last turn and drew even with Luke McGook and from there the pair paced furiously to the wire where Rooster Bennett was able to forge forward by a head and win in 1:56.2.

Bred and owned by Nancy Longobardi and Domenic Longobardi, the George Ducharme-trained Rooster Bennett returned \$2.20.

The second division of this group also had a great stretch duel where **So Rock N' Roll** (Western Maverick—So So Sweet) came up big late to claim the win.

So Rock N' Roll (Kevin Switzer Jr.) took the lead off the gate but Your Brother (Bruce Ranger) made a move past the quarter and gained the front before the half. So Rock N' Roll then sat in the pocket behind the leader to three-quarters where the pair broke away from the field. When they straightened out for home, Switzer tipped out and unleashed So Rock N' Roll who then methodically paced right by Your Brother under a line drive to win by one length in 1:57.1, which was a new lifetime mark.

So Rock N' Roll (\$2.20) is trained by Marc Tardif for owner Leighton Property. Leslie Leighton is the winning breeder.

The best of the male trotters this week was **Yo Lucky Moni** (International Moni—Unbelindyble) who sat behind a speed duel and pounced late for the win.

Te Amo Lindy (Yannick Gingras) took the lead but Inter Mischief (Kevin Switzer Jr.) who got away third, pulled quickly and was next to the leader at the quarter pole in :28.1. However he was unable to gain the lead and Te Amo Lindy rimmed Inter Mischief to the half in :57.1 and three-quarters in 1:27.1 while Yo Lucky Moni (Jimmy Whittemore) drafted right behind them. In the last turn Inter Mischief finally tired, giving Yo Lucky Moni the out he needed. While still two lengths behind Te Amo Lindy at the head of the stretch, Whittemore got after Yo Lucky Moni who then got in gear and really started to trot. He flew down the lane and caught Te Amo Lindy by a neck at the line and won in 1:56.1.

Yo Lucky Moni (\$8.00) is owned by Verlin Yoder and is trained by Marrissa Chadbourne. Lindy Farms of Connecticut bred the winner.

Finally in the filly pacing division, **Dame** (Dude's The Man—Seat By The Window) bested her peers as the only gate to wire stake winner of the day.

Jimmy Hardy pushed Dame hard for the front and out-fought Seafood Beauty (Jay Randall) for that privilege. Dame crossed over just past the :28 quarter and then laid down the law from there. After getting no legitimate challenge for the next half mile, Dame opened up a two length advantage by three-quarters that she kept all the way to the line where she won in 1:55.1.

Dame (\$6.60) was bred and is owned by Stephen Richard and is trained by Jolene Andrews.

Ronnie Wrenn Jr. notches 7,000th career win Monday at MGM Northfield Park

Ronnie Wrenn Jr. made his 7,000th trip to the winner's circle after scoring with Just Bookem in MGM Northfield Park's fifth race on Monday (Oct. 3).

He won the 2013 and 2014 national dash driving titles, finished third in 2015 and 2016, fifth in 2017, second in 2018, fourth in 2019, second in 2020 and was third in 2021.

Among those congratulating Wrenn in the winner's circle were his wife Briana and sons Easton and William.
