The 2024 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale concluded Friday night (Oct. 4) with both the second-best gross and average in history.

In all, the 910 yearlings sold over the five days produced a total gross of \$65,704,700 and an average of \$72,203. The median was \$40,000 and 187 yearlings sold for \$100,000 or more, down from both last year (233) and 2022 (196).

This year's gross was behind only the \$67,916,300 set in 2023 when the auction set 12 records. It's important to note 38 fewer horses were sold this year compared to last.

Preferred Equine set a new sales record with more than \$12.5 million in sales.

It is the third straight year the sale has had sale in excess of \$65 million.

This year's average is second-best to the record of \$73,690 set in 2022 when 25 fewer horses sold.

"We were very close to the all-time record average despite selling more horses, so we feel it was a great auction," said sale co-manager Bruce Brinkerhoff. "We appreciate the great horses that consignors brought to offer and I think the buyers responded accordingly all week."

Sale co-manager David Reid added, "You end up with a sale averaging \$73,000 with 906 horses sold, I mean, that's second-best in the history of the sport. If we continue to do that and keep swinging for the fences and bringing in a line up like we do every year, then I think that's quite an accomplishment for any sales company... but I'm proud to say it's for the Lexington one."

Though no *total* sale records were set this year, the 2024 auction did set the following five records:

- First session average \$190,547
- Second session average \$97,678
- Fifth-session # of yearlings sold for \$100,000 or more -8
- Cumulative average through the first two sessions \$129,265
- Cumulative average through the first three sessions \$97,996

Friday's session — which featured mostly "regional" midwestern horses — grossed \$4,663,700 for 139 sold for an average of \$33,552. A record eight yearlings sold for \$100,000 or more. The median was \$25,000. It was the second-best gross for a fifth session behind only the \$4,854,000 reached in 2022. The average was second behind the average of \$35,174 from 2022.

"We had tremendous response on our Ohio-breds today," Brinkerhoff said. "We also had quite a few Indiana-breds, as well, for good prices. It's come to be known as the day for regional programs here in Lexington and, once again, it's proven to be a great marketplace for those horses.

First-time sellers Enos and Lexi Weaver of Weaver Standardbreds said they were pleased with their Lexington experience.

"Today was a great session. We were up over last year's session and it helped create a great wind up or ending to a great week of sales."

Reid added, "It was a really energetic crowd. The Buckeyes came to town and we had a good night. It was a good sale, with the average right on par with what it has been the last three or four years.

"Downbytheseaside is obviously the staple, but I was happy to see the first-crop sires on the trotting side, Ready For Moni held up very well.


"I think this night works perfect in the rotation. There were a lot of new faces here tonight. It was energetic and I thought it was a very good night for sure."

In terms of a total sale money breakdown, it was as follows:

- Yearlings selling for \$200,000 or more 71 (7.8 per cent)
- \bullet Yearlings selling between \$100,000 and \$199,999 116 (12.7 per cent)
- Yearlings selling between \$50,000 and \$99,999 220 (24.2 per cent)
- \bullet Yearlings selling between \$25,000 and \$49,999 246 (27 per cent)
- \bullet Yearlings selling between \$10,000 and \$24,999 206 (22.6 per cent)
- Yearlings selling between \$5,000 and \$9,999 50 (5.5 per cent)
- Yearlings selling for 4,999 or less -1 (0.1 per cent)

PREFERRED FIRST CONSIGNOR TO EVER TOP \$12 MILLION

In other notable numbers, Reid's Preferred Equine became the first Lexington consignor in history to top \$12 million in sales. The sales agency ended the auction with gross sales of \$12,588,000 for 165 yearlings sold.



"That's a big number," Reid said. "Even on a night like tonight, we sold the second-highest priced pacer for \$150,000. There was another that sold for \$160,000."

They were followed by Kentuckiana with total sales of \$9,347,700 for 131 sold and Hunterton with \$9,027,000 in sales for 94 sold.

Hanover Shoe Farms, which sold 13 yearlings over the first two sessions, was the leading consignor by average at \$216,318. They were followed by All American Harnessbreds (\$136,889) and Cameo Hills (\$112,469).

SESSION-TOPPER BRINGS \$160,000

Topping Friday's session was Hip #870 Spoil Me Silly, a Swan For All filly out of Wishimaywishimight purchased for \$160,000 by M & L of Delaware LLC and sold by Kentuckiana Farms.

Hip #810 Malibu Barbie Deo, a Downbytheseaside filly out of Miss L A, fetched \$150,000 from Odds On Racing LLC from the Preferred consignment.

Hip #851 Sweet Wave, a Downbytheseaside colt out of Hula Shuffle, was purchased for \$145,000 by Jodi Schillachi out of the All American Harnessbreds consignment.

Beth Yontz of Anvil And Lace said the farm had "a very good sale."

WEAVERS PLEASED WITH FIRST CONSIGNMENT

Enos Weaver, whose Weaver Standardbred Farm sold for the first time in Lexington, said it was a good experience.

"We had a good week and we're very happy," Weaver said. "It was great, people were great. We had a lot of fun and a great week. Hopefully we'll be back next year."

Anvil And Lace's Beth Yontz said she thought the farm had a "very good sale. We had our ups and downs, which you always have, but overall I thought it went really well.

"Splash Blue Chip's [Hip #35, Kountry Splash, \$175,000] brought nice money the first night, then we had an American Ideal colt that brought over \$100,000, which was very good for him. He's a very nice colt.

"I think opening night was just phenomenal. It kind of goes down a little throughout the week, but now that we're at Friday, it's all here again. They did have Ohio-breds and the [Downbytheseasides] spread throughout the whole sale, but the majority are still here [selling on Friday] so it brings a whole new excitement."

HARRIS, POLLOCK SPENT \$2.5 MILLION MORE THAN NEXT CLOSEST

Despite not buying a single horse in the last three sessions, the tandem of Andrew Harris and Bill Pollock dominated the buyers' standings with \$5,115,000 spent, total, to take home 15 yearlings. Nancy Takter was second with total purchases of \$2,626,000 for 24 yearlings, followed by Tony Alagna (\$2,316,000 for 30 yearlings) and Ake Svanstedt (\$2,127,000 for 12).

Alagna was still active during the fifth and final sessions.

"There was a Trixton filly that I bought," Alagna said. "I saw her when I went up to Jim Avritt's farm to look at some other horses. She was kind of one of those ones that I thought if I could buy her in the right range with her having dual eligibility, then I'd take a shot. So, I got her bought.


"Then, I also came out to support John Barnhard. He's one of my clients and has Fiftydallarbill in Indiana, so I wanted to make sure his horses sold okay.

"This type of sale when a lot of them had dual eligibility so people are waking up to that. With us having the farm in Kentucky, it's easier for us to race in Ohio and venture into Indiana a little bit more than we used to."

TROTTERS DOMINATE SIRE LIST

The first four sires on the money list were all trotters:

- Walner \$8,936,000 for 51 sold (\$175,216 average).
- Chapter Seven \$7,581,000 for 50 sold (\$151,620).
- Muscle Hill \$4,349,000 for 35 sold (\$124,257).
- Gimpanzee \$4,089,000 for 42 sold (\$97,357).

The top pacer was Captaintreacherous (\$3,867,000 for 42 sold (\$97,071)). But, Downbytheseaside thoroughly dominated the final session with \$1,941,000 in sales (for 34 sold) to jump up to sixth overall, just behind Captaintreacherous in the complete sale list. Overall, Downbytheseasides had \$3,588,000 in sales for 45 sold.

"Downbytheseasides are always great to sell," Reid said. "He's a stallion on a national level, but he just happens to be in Ohio. This year, we tried a little something different by putting some [of his] in earlier in the week. We'll go back through and reassess that whole situation, but I thought they held up very well tonight and it's just a bookend of a great week."

As for the most prominent first-crop sires, they were as follows:

- Perfect Sting \$3,159,000 for 46 sold.
- Captain Corey \$2,549,000 for 39 sold.
- Bulldog Hanover \$882,000 for 9 sold.
- Ready For Moni \$795,000 for 18 sold.

CANADIANS MADE UP 11 PER CENT OF TOTAL SALES

Canadian buyers spent \$7,257,000 in all, about 11 per cent of the total sales. European buyers accounted for 4.6 per cent of

the purchases after spending just over \$3 million in total.

As for U.S. buyers, those living in New Jersey dominated (\$22,256,000 in sales), followed by Florida (\$7,301,000), Pennsylvania (\$4,707,000), Ohio (\$4,308,000), Delaware (\$4,263,000) and New York (\$4,248,000).

Overall, Reid and Brinkerhoff said the sale more than met expectations.

"We set session records, average-wise, for most days this year," Brinkerhoff said. "We're very pleased about that. It carried from the very beginning of the sale and all the way through to the end of the auction. We had tremendous participation and we're very pleased.

Reid added, "I probably sound like a broken record but when we were out there looking at the horses and you're doing the catalog, the pages just keep

getting better and better. It's not a perfect science, but the quality of the animals that are being presented to us by the consignors is very strong."


Chris and Nick happened to be by the breakfast table when I arrived around 8:30 and applauded. Finally! Finally! Yes, finally! I saw bagels.



Moss to start Kentucky Futurity before stepping away from the gate

After more than four decades starting horses in Kentucky, Indiana and Illinois, Mike Moss will close out his time in the car on a high note Sunday (Oct. 6) at The Red Mile. The 66-year-old Bluegrass native has served as the starter during Lexington's two-week Grand Circuit meet, headlined by Sunday's Kentucky Futurity.

"I'm not a bucket list guy, but I have always hoped that someday I could do the Grand Circuit races," Moss said. "It's exciting. I like to start good horses."


Moss has been synonymous with the starting gate for decades. His father, Bob, purchased a starting car in the late 1970s, and Mike found himself behind the wheel as part of the family business. Before that, he was the wheel man for Layton Swinford.

"I drove the car for Mr. Swinford for a long time and then I drove for my dad," Mike said. "I started from the ground up. Dad began as a starter the year that the fairs came back to Kentucky. He helped get the wheels rolling again to get the Kentucky fairs active."

Driving for his disabled father, Mike learned the business of starting. When Bob surprisingly turned over the reins in Lebanon, KY, his son may have been apprehensive, but he was ready.

"I was going to help my dad get in the back of the car because, with his condition, he couldn't just jump up in there," Mike said. "I said, 'Hey, we've got to get ready for this race.' He said, 'I'm going to drive the car today.' I was 21. We were at Lebanon, Kentucky. I'll never forget it. He said, 'You're starting today.' I replied, 'I don't have my license.' He said, 'Yeah you do, here they are right here.' He had done the legwork and got my license. That's how I learned, driving the car helping him. When I got back there it was just natural because he had taught me."

And it has been natural ever since. When his father's condition worsened, Mike purchased the car, and served in the role in the Bluegrass State, Hoosier State and Illinois going forward. Working in the corporate world, he relied on vacation time to map out the summer schedule.

On Sunday, Mike Moss (with his wife Lynn) will start the Kentucky Futurity card and then retire from starting races.

"It was always a little bit of a challenge because my corporate work never mixed with horses," Mike said. "I tried to keep it separated. I had enough vacation time that I could go to the fairs. The only thing that would mess me up is if we had a rainout."

Mike maintained that schedule of balancing corporate work with starting races for 25 years. When he stepped away from his role of running a regional phone company, he added another industry position: ID technician with the USTA. He has held that position for 18 years, first covering Kentucky, Tennessee and Georgia. With the resurgence of racing and breeding in Kentucky, he now focuses solely on the work in his home state.

"I'm very fortunate," he said. "With the Kentucky program going, it's been very good to me. It gives me flexibility and I can do my starting with that."

In the fall of 2022, Mike made the difficult decision to sell his starting car and get out of the business, focusing only on starting at The Red Mile during the summer.

"It was hard because it was something my dad and I had done for so long," Mike said. "I did it for all those years. But it got so expensive. The insurance was crazy high. The fuel, motels, paying someone to drive, keeping up the car. It just got really, really expensive."

Today, Mike still returns to the Indiana State Fair, this time serving as an associate judge. He said he enjoys the experience, but admits that when he held the same role at Lexington for a year, it wasn't a good fit.

Mike Moss said he's looking forward to starting great horses and drivers.

"That's just not me," he said. "It's not my gift. I feel more comfortable out on the dirt with the drivers, with the trainers. If I screw up it's on me. If they screw up, we talk about it. I'm more of a hands-on quy."

That hands-on approach has also opened other doors. Mike began working at yearling sales representing the USTA. Now, he has parlayed that into opportunities at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale, Ohio Selected Jug Sale, Harrisburg and Hoosier Classic Sale Company's trio of auctions.

"Eight years ago, Randy Manges asked me to start looking at yearlings," Mike said. "Bruce Brinkerhoff had gone to the USTA, and he had gone with Randy each year to look at yearlings. When I began looking at yearlings, I started working more with the sale."

Mike now helps Brinkerhoff review yearlings in Ohio and Indiana.

With the resurgence of the Kentucky program, Mike has had the pleasure of starting some of the top horses which now compete at The Red Mile throughout the summer.

"Obviously, it's a great place to race horses," Mike said. "The last few years we've had the luxury of having dual-eligible horses come through, so it has raised the level of horses and drivers."

Traditionally, Mike has started races at The Red Mile leading up to the Grand Circuit meet. However, during the final two weeks in Lexington, Greg Coon takes over. This year, Coon shared he was not physically up to the duties, and, with the permission of management, was tagging Mike in if he wanted the opportunity.

Twin B Joe Fresh updates and Kentucky Futurity preview



With suddenly just three weeks until the Breeders Crown finals, Twin B Joe Fresh continues her persistent hold over Jiggy Jog S as being the sports top-rated horse for the 12th consecutive week. If the Hambletonian Society/ Breeders Crown weekly poll is a reflection of how Dan Patch voting will go — in this case, I believe it is — then it may only take a couple more starts and wins for Twin B Joe Fresh to nail down the rare feat of being named Horse of the Year as an older pacing mare.

I spoke with Twin B Joe Fresh trainer, Chris Ryder earlier in the week to get a sense of where he was at with his star mare. Normally I would have provided actual quotes from that talk here but due to my error and the conversation having not recorded, here is a paraphrased synopsis instead.

Following another dominant win, most recently last Saturday at Dayton in the Dayton Distaff Derby, Ryder confirmed that Twin B Joe Fresh will train up to the Breeders Crown. She'll look to qualify next week at The Meadowlands before going to the Breeders Crown, either in an elimination or straight to the final the following week if no elimination is necessary. If all goes well, she will likely close out her season on Nov. 30 once again at The Meadowlands in the FanDuel FFA Championship mare pace.

With that plan, Ryder said that taking on male rivals — something that I suggested — wasn't something that he was inclined to do right now. My thought in asking the question is that it's almost never attempted for a mare pacer to race against FFA males, but if there's ever been a situation where it could be tried and maybe even accomplished successfully, this would be the time to try it. Twin B Joe Fresh has been untouchable all year long in the open mare division and on paper isn't much different than any of the top males. Just last Saturday at Dayton, Twin B Joe Fresh's win time in 1:48.3 was a full second



quicker than Abuckabett Hanover's 1:49.3 which came two races later in the Dayton Pacing Derby. Between how good Twin B Joe Fresh has been and a male FFA group which isn't exactly an all-time best, the mare would have had a real chance.

Ryder did give indications however, that even after Nov. 30 we may have not seen the last of Twin B Joe Fresh. More likely than not it seemed; the current plan is to race back Twin B Joe Fresh next year as a 5-year-old. Ryder also commented that Twin B Joe Fresh winning Horse of the Year this year is something that's admittedly been on his mind (how could it not be with her being in the driver's seat much of the year), and that if she did win the award this year, that Ryder could be open to taking greater risks with Twin B Joe Fresh next year, which could include racing against the boys.

As an aside, I do wonder how voters split between Twin B Joe Fresh and Jiggy Jog S, and Hambletonian champion Karl for that matter too. There's no right or wrong answer, I'm genuinely curious. Perhaps Jiggy Jog S is second because she's only raced six times. But on the other hand, she's never lost and one of those wins includes a \$1 million race against national and international male rivals. I know it's different racing against males for trotters than it is for pacers, but these two-superstar mares seem impossible to separate. Maybe something in the next few weeks will cause further distinction.

Switching gears and onto closing day Sunday at the Red Mile, Karl lands what looks to be an overzealous 6-5 morning line in the Kentucky Futurity. But before getting into that race, one horse that I wish was in that race but isn't, is Vic Zelenskyy who goes a few races earlier in a \$50,000 event for Futurity eligibles.

Had Vic Zelenskyy raced in the Futurity, it would have been highly intriguing to see if he could go from breaking in a non-winner of 1 in July to now winning the Futurity; I think he could have. A \$550,000 yearling two years ago as a son out of Mission Brief, he was plagued by immaturity but his last two have been spectacular; sort of reminds of Tactical Landing as a 2 and 3-year-old. The way he trotted into another world through the stretch in his Goldenrod win two back was truly something you rarely see. Amazingly, he was nearly just as good last out where I don't think the race chart does him justice when he was actually parked three-wide for the entire second half and was still moving forward late to be second. He offers no wagering potential in a small field of six as a total all-or-nothing type, but is worth keeping tabs on for later.

To the contrary, the Kentucky Futurity is easily the best race on the card not only in terms of obvious quality but in wagering opportunity. Of course, Karl could win, but from the second tier in a field of formful competition anything can happen. Karl was touched off in his most recent by Dame Good Time who passed him up the inside, and it's worth noting that Secret Agent Man may have been right there as well if not for his break when moving up alongside Karl in the stretch. Takter elected to skip last week's Bluegrass to have him ready for the Futurity.

I suppose Karl will be favored but wouldn't be shocked if that role ends up going to Highland Kismet who may be able to get a cleaner trip from post 3. After an unfortunate miscue in the Canadian Trotting Classic, he crushed last week in the Bluegrass in the off going. He went a huge mile first-over when being second best to Karl in the Hambletonian and will be out for revenge. Fresh off the upset of Karl, Dame Good Time picks up a new driver in Tetrick as Zeron now goes to Security Protected. Sig Sauer looked about to be overtaken in the NJ Classic final by eventual winner Tony Adams S when he broke, and this will be the first race in a month for both those horses. Amazing Catch used some Dunn magic to overcome post 10 where that driver continues to make the improbable look normal. Secret Agent Man just missed to Karl three back and may have won against that rival two back, as mentioned above. He was strong on the front end in the Bluegrass and is my pick to win the 132nd Kentucky Futurity.

Chapter Seven and his far from finished legacy

In the aftermath of the fantastic Day 1 of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale, one cannot help but to be impressed by the performance of the great trotting sire Chapter Seven and his perhaps equally impressive, some might think superior, son Walner. If it were up to me, I'd be more than content, if given a choice of the two with the one not chosen.

Consider this. There were a total of 72 trotting-bred yearlings that underwent the rigorous process to have been chosen as a Day 1 yearling, traditionally the Ne Plus Ultra, the Best of the Best nominated to the number one yearling sale of the breed. Of those 72, 46 (64 per cent) of them were by Chapter Seven and his son Walner.

The trotting bred yearlings selling on Day 1 amassed a total of \$15,951,000; \$10,402,000 (65 per cent) of that total went for yearlings sired by Chapter Seven and Walner.

When I think of Chapter Seven, I think in terms of great trotting sires like Stars Pride, Valley Victory, and Muscle Hill and perhaps, to a lesser degree, Rodney, Speedy Crown, Super Bowl and Muscle Hill who have had the trotting world revolve around their dominance. There are very few stallions in the history of our breed who have reached that status.

When referencing the type of horse that I believe Chapter Seven to be, I think a line from William Shakespeare's Julius Caesar best describes them: *He doth bestride the Narrow World Like A Colossus*. That would be my present-day description of Chapter Seven.

How did it come about? I first went to the source, my friend Linda Toscano, who had the good sense and perhaps good fortune to train Chapter Seven as a yearling and then do the same with his thus far greatest son in the stud, Walner. Before I go any further, I need to give credit to the late Pat Waldo who not only "discovered" Chapter Seven for his owner Richard Gutnick, but also did the same for Valley Victory for Arlene Traub who bought him as a yearling. Imagine if you would, two generational stallions somewhat emanating from the same source! One needs to understand that we are not speaking of gimme yearlings, the ones that click all the boxes at the sale and are destined to become sales toppers.

Chapter Seven was purchased as a yearling from the 2009 Harrisburg Sale for \$42,000 by Gutnick acting upon the advice





of Waldo. Valley Victory had been purchased for \$60,000 at the 1987 Tattersalls Sale by Traub acting on Waldo's urging.

At the beginning, all was not well for this rising superstar stallion. When he was first turned out in a paddock, he jumped the fence and tore his flank. That resulted in several stitches. The first time he was hooked to a jog cart, he was observed to have been making a noise. The diagnosis was an entrapped epiglottis. Surgery to correct it was deemed necessary.

"If he keeps going like this, he will break me before he even gets to race," said owner Gutnick with a laugh. That brought about his name being changed to Chapter Seven.

"He was so full of himself in his early training that we sometimes needed two people to lead him on and off the track, for fear



of him doing further damage to himself and perhaps inflicting some on those around him," Toscano said. "He was very talented, maybe too talented for his own good.

"When it came time to qualify him, I enlisted Mike Lachance to do it. Through the years, Mike has probably qualified hundreds of horses for me. When he brought him back, Mike said 'Linda, this is the very best horse you have ever had."

Those who know Lachance know that that is no minor statement. Lachance is not one to throw around those type of superlatives.

"Despite having sickness issues through his career [he had pneumonia twice], he went on to a very distinguished racing career. Was he a great horse in the terms reserved for the greatest in the history of the breed? Probably not, but nonetheless he enjoyed a quite satisfying career and raced extremely well at 2, 3 and 4, before retiring at the conclusion of his 4-year-old season as 2012 Trotter of the Year.

"When it came time to retire him, Richard was offered a syndication deal for him to stand at Blue Chip Farms. I'd be lying if I said that I expected what was going to happen to actually happen. I think that for me, and probably just about everyone else in the business, the expectations were that he was probably destined to become a very nice regional horse, a horse that would comport himself very well in the New York Sires Stakes, with perhaps the odd horse winning an occasional Grand Circuit event."

We were all wrong, very wrong!

Chapter Seven's first crop arriving in 2014 numbered 83. The mares they were out of were okay, neither great, nor poor. The expectations were that they would probably race according to expectations. From the very first, he was to show that the expectations were significantly underrated.

Included among them was a very good trotter by the name of Eye Of The Tiger, who went on to earn \$972,586. But the star of that group was a striking brown colt named Walner who was also first given his lessons by Toscano. He was sold at Lexington and brought \$90,000 for the account of Ken Jacobs.

"He was very special, right from day one" Toscano said. "He had the most remarkable presence of any horse that I've ever been around before or since. He gave the impression that he was lightning in a bottle from the very first time we hooked him up. He had more speed than his father, actually more speed than any other horse I've ever had in my stable. When he raced, he was dominant. Unfortunately, a very minor injury necessitated his being retired, syndicated and put in the stud. I've always felt that he could have been rehabbed and come back to race showing his true greatness. But I firmly understand that he was far more valuable to the breed in the stud barn than he would have been on the racetrack."

Chapter Seven's second crop numbered 71, they included the multiple world champion and Hambletonian winner Atlanta (\$3,533,707).

His third crop numbered only 49, but they included the great world champion and now rising young sire Gimpanzee (\$2,701,075).

With each succeeding crop, he has continued to produce champion after champion including the Hambletonian winner Cool Papa Bell and the great international superstar Jovialty S (\$2,542.787 internationally).

This year his star of stars is the amazing 2-year-old Maryland (nee Charlie K Hanover), who pre-Breeders Crown has already collected \$795,378. He seems a lock for 2-Year-Old Trotter of the Year and in a non Jiggy Jog S (sired by his son Walner) year might be in consideration for Trotter of the Year.

Tom Grossman at whose Blue Chip Farms Chapter Seven stands said that it took both him and the other syndicate shareholders a little while to figure out the type of mares that suit Chapter Seven best in order to get a perhaps more robust specimen. He is now doing it with a whole lot more frequency.

"After those first two crops, I bought all the shares I could get," Grossman said. "So now my investment in this great stallion is far more substantial than it originally was."

Chapter Seven leads all categories for money won by his progeny this year: 2-year-olds, 3-year-olds, and all ages!







Looksgoodinloulou equals world record in International Stallion Stakes

After faltering to Papi Grad in a first-over push last week, **Looksgoodinloulou** found herself on Papi Grad's trail and zoomed through a seam at the inside to win the \$81,600 Bob McIntosh Memorial, part of the \$245,800 International Stallion Stakes (ISS) for 2-year-old pacing fillies, in a world-record equaling mile on Friday (Oct. 4) at The Red Mile.

Driver Yannick Gingras zipped out of post 7 with Looksgoodinloulou, the 3-2 second choice, and grabbed the lead to a :26.3 first quarter as Papi Grad (driven by Dexter Dunn) plotted her next move while racing in third. Dunn decided to vacate his position and brush forward up the backside to take

over control from Looksgoodinloulou before a half clocked in :53.4. Papi Grad carried the field through to three-quarters in 1:22.1 under intensifying pressure with Duration (Todd McCarthy) mounting a first-over bid and clearance gradually opening to the inside for Looksgoodinloulou. Looksgoodinloulou capitalized on the real estate and surged by Papi Grad in the final eighth to pull away to a 1¾-length victory in 1:48.3. Papi Grad held second while Champagne Room (Andy McCarthy) rallied from second over for third and Duration settled for fourth.

"It's all the Burke Brigade," said Gingras after the race. "They got all these homebreds – last year, they were one-two-three with those fillies in the Breeders Crown. [Burke and company] got better mares and Sweet Lou obviously has been producing like crazy. I'm just lucky to sit behind them."

Trainer Burke and Gingras also teamed to establish the track and world record of 1:48.3 for 2-year-old pacing fillies back in 2018 with another daughter of Sweet Lou, Warrawee Ubeaut.

Looksgoodinloulou is a homebred Sweet Lou filly for Burke Racing Stable LLC and Weaver Bruscemi LLC. She won her third race from six starts, has now banked \$240,175 and paid \$5.12 to win.

Burke scored another decisive win in the \$81,600 first division of the ISS, the Margareta Wallenius-Kleberg Memorial, with 7-5 second choice **Rodeo Drive Deo** (David Miller) powering uncovered to a 1:50.1 win.

Miller pushed Rodeo Drive Deo off the wings from post 7 but took back as the inside three fired forward into a :27.1 first quarter. Simply Perfect (T. McCarthy) landed on the lead while Rodeo Drive Deo settled into fourth and waited until a :55.1 half to commit outside and roll uncovered on the rim. Rodeo Drive Deo progressed through the far turn to reach Simply Perfect's throat and then vaulted to the lead after three-quarters in 1:23. Unreasonable (Scott Zeron), who tracked from second over through the turn, angled out to take a shot late, but Rodeo Drive Deo kept fighting to hold off that challenger by a half-length at the beam. Calamity Hour (Dunn) came from third over for third while Beyonsay Yankee (Tim Tetrick) sat a ground-saving trip for fourth.

"She's been just awesome," Miller said after the race. "I got to race her four times now, and I can't praise her enough."

Rodeo Drive Deo races for Burke Racing Stable LLC, Weaver Bruscemi LLC, Beasty LLC and J & T Silva—Purnel & Libby. The Captaintreacherous filly won her third race from seven starts and has now earned \$150,757. She paid \$4.84 to win.

Burke completed a sweep of the ISS filly paces with 1-9 favorite Rose (Gingras) scoring an authoritative 1:50.3 victory in the closing division.

Gingras powered Rose from the pylon post for the lead but took a brief pocket as Cant See Me (Bob McClure) swooped from post 8 for the front to a :27.2 first quarter. Rose abandoned the pocket ride and circled back to the top on the backstretch to take the field to the half in :55.3. Cant See Me boldly pulled the pocket rounding the final turn as the tempo slowed to three-quarters in 1:24.1 but quickly levelled off as Rose hit the pedal and scooted away. Rose registered a 3¼-length victory over pylon-skimming Point Breeze (James MacDonald) in second, while Accede (Dunn) closed from third over for third and Chakra (Anibal Borjas) closed for fourth.

A daughter of Sweet Lou, Rose won her seventh race from eight starts and has now banked \$337,213 for owners Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi, Jack Piatt III and Larry Karr. She paid \$2.30 to win.

Division 1 of the ISS was named "The Margareta Wallenius-Kleberg Memorial" sponsored by Arden Homestead Stable, E. T. Gerry, Jr., Peter Gerry, Stoner Manor Inc., Menhammar Stuteri AB, Jorgen Jahre Jr., LST Stable, Lawrence DeVan and William DeVan. The Bob McIntosh Memorial was sponsored by the Perfect Sting Syndicate, Brittany Farms and Val D'Or Farms, and the third division was named "The Arlene Siegel Memorial" sponsored by Jules Siegel and Fashion Farms.

MEMENTO MORI WINS INTERNATIONAL STALLION STAKES

Steady handling from Zeron helped keep **Memento Mori** flat gaited as he catapulted off a pocket ride to win the second of four divisions for the \$320,000 International Stallion Stakes for

2-year-old trotting colts and geldings in 1:51.4 on Friday (Oct. 4) at The Red Mile.

With 2-5 favorite Happy Jack B (driven by Ake Svanstedt) bolting for the lead from the pylon post, Zeron settled Memento Mori into the pocket on the move to a :28 first quarter. Happy Jack B scurried up the backside to stretch the field behind him and clock a :55.1 half, though he slowed the tempo rounding the final turn. Big Shoes (Gingras) launched an attack first over coming to three-quarters in 1:24 but stalled spinning into the stretch while Happy Jack B hit the accelerator again and Memento Mori tried to shake free from a tight pocket. Zeron gave Memento Mori a clear path and held his charge together as he bobbled in stride but promptly smoothened and gathered momentum to collar Happy Jack B at the line by a half-length. Big Shoes finished third and Go Boom (Mattias Melander) sat a pylon trip for fourth.

"[The connections] were high on him all year," Zeron said after the race. "Seems like we had second-itis for a while. He's been learning as he goes. Last week was the first time they pulled his shoes and they did it again today. Obviously, we finally had a trip – if you watch him close, he's always been a little too far back charging at the end."

The mile was three-fifths of a second off the record for 2-year-old trotting colts set in 2020 by Southwind Tyrion, but just over a second slower than the fastest mile ever by a trotting 2-year-old of 1:50.3 set by the filly Mission Brief in 2014.

A gelding by Chapter Seven, Memento Mori won his second race from 10 starts and has now banked \$134,276 for owners Thestable Memento Mori and Hutchison Harness LLC. Eric Patalan trains the gelding who paid \$11.38 to win.

Onajetplane (A. McCarthy) soared forward as the tempo slowed and coasted to a 1:52.2 victory in the first division of the ISS colt trot.

The Rogue Prince (Tetrick) steamrolled to the lead after a :28.4 first quarter and sped up the backside to a :55.4 half. Though the headstrong leader started to sputter midway around the final turn and slowed the tempo, prompting A. McCarthy to angle Onajetplane off the pegs from fourth and launch his bid for the lead. Onajetplane flew past The Rogue Prince after three-quarter in 1:24 and got the jump on his foes in the stretch. Onajetplane strolled over the line a 1¾-length winner over Tactical Dynasty (Gingras), who gave chase second over turning for home. Civilian Drone (MacDonald) rallied from near last for third and Elan Hanover (T. McCarthy) rallied for fourth.

"We were able to take [shoes] off for three of his starts now – he won two of them and was pretty unlucky in the Mohawk Million; didn't get the greatest of trips," trainer Noel Daley said after the race. "He's fine with it and has great feet."

A colt by Walner, Onajetplane won his third race from eight starts and has now earned \$232,780 for owners Noel Daley, Sjoblom Racing Inc., L. A. Express Stable LLC and Mr. Joonas Jarvinen. He paid \$5.10 to win.

Gap Kronos S (Svanstedt) pushed past galloping Go Dog Go (T. McCarthy) in the stretch to snag the third ISS division for trotting colts in 1:51.4.

Go Dog Go grabbed the lead to a :28.2 first quarter and kept the speed hot up the backside to click by a :55.4 half. Svanstedt pulled Gap Kronos S out of fourth and marched forward uncovered through the final turn while Go Dog Go appeared strong on the helm. By three-quarters in 1:24.1, Go Dog Go spun for home on a loose lead before getting wobbly gaited again in late stretch. He broke stride inside the final eighth and ducked inside to avoid traffic all while Gap Kronos S kept his momentum and glided by to a three-length win. Following a disqualification of Go Dog Go from second to sixth for violation of the breaking rule and interference, Hidalgo (Gingras) took second with Meshuggah (Zeron) third and Monserrate (Miller) fourth.

Svanstedt trains Gap Kronos S, a colt by Face Time Bourbon, for owner Bruni Racing Team Inc. He won his third race from six starts and has now earned \$91,395. He paid \$7.72 to win.

Super Chapter (Dunn) delivered as the 1-5 favorite in the final division of the ISS colt trot, stopping the clock in 1:52.


Dunn planted Super Chapter onto the point moving for a :27.4 first quarter but yielded for a pocket ride behind Maximus Mearas S (Zeron) into the backside. Maximus Mearas S maintained control to a :55.4 half while Dunn waited to strike with Super Chapter until the far turn. Super Chapter rushed to the lead moving around the final turn and gained separation on Maximus Mearas S plodding through three-quarters in 1:24.2. The Marcus Melander trainee had the race sealed in the lane and strolled in a 31⁄4-length winner over Maximus Mearas S while Chat Room (Gingras) came from second over for third and Hey Porter (Miller) saved ground for fourth.


"We got two really nice colts this year, this one and Maryland," Marcus said after the race. "Hopefully they can stay sound and healthy the rest of the year and we can have some fun."

Winning his fifth race from eight starts, Super Chapter has now earned \$376,230 for owners Jeff Snyder and Arthur Pronti. The Chapter Seven colt paid \$2.66 to win.

Division 1 of the ISS was named "The Six Pack" sponsored by the Six Pack Syndicate and Deo Volente Farms. Division 2 was named "The Muscle Hill" sponsored by Southwind Farms, division 3 was named "The Walner" sponsored by the Walner Syndicate and division 4 was named "The Tactical Landing" sponsored by Hickory Lane Farm and the Tactical Landing Syndicate.

Live racing resumes today (Oct. 5) with three divisions of the \$300,900 International Stallion Stakes for 2-year-old pacing colts and geldings and five divisions of the \$342,000 International Stallion Stakes for 2-year-old trotting fillies on the 15-race card. First-race post time is 1 p.m. (EDT).







Karl, Date Night Hanover face post-position test in Kentucky Futurities

Hambletonian champ Karl and Kentucky Championship Series winner Date Night Hanover will attempt to overcome their draws as the morning-line favorites in the \$500,000 Kentucky Futurity and \$301,550 Kentucky Filly Futurity, respectively, on Sunday (Oct. 6) at The Red Mile.

Karl, anointed as the 6-5 chalk, drew the lone slot in the second tier and will trail 10 rivals behind the starting gate in the 132nd Kentucky Futurity. The Nancy Takter-trained colt by Tactical Landing, with just over \$2 million on his card, makes his first appearance since suffering only his third defeat from 21 starts in the \$400,000 Kentucky Championship Series final, where he was upended in the closing strides by a pylonskimming Dame Good Time (racing from post 2 in the Futurity) in a 1:50.2 mile. Yannick Gingras will drive Karl from the trailing spot.

The field of 11 for the Kentucky Futurity has lured several high-status foes looking to down Karl, including Hambletonian runner-up Highland Kismet from post 3. The Mark Etsell-trained Father Patrick gelding adds hopples back onto his loadout following a facile 1:55.1 win in a Bluegrass division over a sloppy track last Saturday. Bob McClure sits in the bike and will start just to the inside of Ake Svanstedt pupil Amazing Catch, who capitalized on Highland Kismet's break in stride in the \$527,620 Canadian Trotting Classic to pull a 19-1 upset in 1:51.4. James MacDonald acquires the drive on the Walner colt who is just one of a three-pronged Svanstedt charge in the Futurity, which includes New Jersey Classic winner Tony Adams S from post 6 and Mr Bluebird from post 7.

Meanwhile, 3-1 morning-line favorite Date Night Hanover will have to deal with the outermost post in the 11-horse field for the 59th Kentucky Filly Futurity. Dexter Dunn drives the Marcus Melander-trained daughter of Chapter Seven out of post 10 following a 1:55 victory under wraps in a Bluegrass division last Saturday. The Zweig Filly Trot champ also faced an outside post in the \$525,000 Hambletonian Oaks earlier this year, in which she made a furious rally at the pylons before hooking wheels and breaking stride to finish ninth.

Date Night Hanover is only the slight choice in the Kentucky Filly Futurity, which also attracted Hambletonian Oaks winner Warrawee Michelle from post 7, Hambletonian Oaks runner-up Buy A Round from post 3, 2023 Dan Patch 2-Year-Old Trotting Filly of the Year Soiree Hanover from post 9 and Elegantimage winner French Champagne from post 11 among the entrants.

Pacing glamour boys will spar earlier on the card in a pair of divisions for the \$422,000 Tattersalls Pace. Division 1 pits Kentucky Championship Series winner Better Is Nice against Anthony Beaton's dynamo Huntsville colt Legendary Hanover, himself looking for his first visit to the winner's circle since Aug. 25. Andy McCarthy pilots Better Is Nice, a Tony Alagna-trained Bettor's Wish colt, off a gutsy 1:53.1 first-over push in a Bluegrass division. He starts from post 6, just to the inside of Legendary Hanover, in a group that also includes 2023 Metro Pace winner Captain's Quarters from post 3 and Little Brown Jug runner-up Mirage Hanover from post 5.

Division 2 of the Tattersalls will see whether Steely Knife can build off his 12-1 Bluegrass upset last week when he starts from post 2 in the field of seven. Gingras gets the drive on the Ron Burke-trained colt by Always B Miki against a bunch that



features Women Layer, runner-up to Better Is Nice in a Bluegrass division last Saturday; McCrunch, runner-up to Steely Knife in the Bluegrass; and Captain Luke, an Alagnatrained colt by Captaintreacherous looking to add to his resume which includes a 1:50.1 win in the \$200,000 Max Hempt Memorial consolation.

The \$233,000 Glen Garnsey Memorial, the filly counterpart to the Tattersalls, also features two divisions on the Sunday card. Rocket Deo, a 1:51.4 winner over My Girl EJ in a Bluegrass division last week, matches up against Jugette champ Soft Shot and another Bluegrass winner in Disney in the first division. Division two features My Girl EJ looking to make amends from a runner-up finish from post 1 as she faces seven rivals including Kentucky Championship Series winner Direction.

Sunday's card also features each sex and gait of older standardbred in the Allerage Farms Stakes. A quintet opens the card in the \$69,500 Allerage Mare Trot and features a powerful Svanstedt duo in Call Me Goo, winner of the \$170,090 Armbro Flight earlier this season when with trainer Jason Skinner, and Nelsonbriteagle NO, entering off a 1:52.3 romp in the \$90,000 Miss Versatility final at Delaware, OH. Svanstedt will pilot Call Me Goo from post 2 while Dunn retains the assignment on Nelsonbriteagle NO from post 5.

Dayton Trotting Derby winner Logan Park will contend from post 5 against Maple Leaf Trot champ Periculum from post 2 in the \$153,000 Allerage Open Trot. Dunn stays with Logan Park, a 6-year-old Archangel gelding, for trainer Robert Fellows while Scott Zeron pilots Periculum, a 5-year-old Muscle Hill stallion, for trainer Melander.

Sylvia Hanover escapes Twin B Joe Fresh in the \$65,500 Allerage Mares Pace. The 4-year-old Always B Miki mare lands post 1 in the sextet and will have McClure in the bike for trainer Mark Steacy.

The penultimate race to the Grand Circuit meet is the \$159,000 Allerage Open Pace, which gathers 10 with nearly \$10 million in collective earnings. Abuckabett Hanover earns slight favoritism as the 5-2 morning-line choice off a 1:49.3 victory in the Dayton Pacing Derby last Saturday and will have Dunn in the bike for trainer Andrew Harris. The field also includes Midwest millionaire Little Rocket Man, who keeps David Miller in the sulky from post 5 for trainer Ken Rucker, and double-millionaire Bythemissal, who has Gingras in the bike for trainer Burke as the 5-year-old Downbytheseaside gelding looks to continue in his return from a three-month layoff out of post 10.

Sunday's card will conclude the 2024 Grand Circuit meet at The Red Mile and features 12 races on the program. First-race post time is 1 p.m. (EDT).





Metro Pace winner Fallout makes return today to Red Mile

Fallout, who dipped from the Kentucky Championship Series and won the \$740,000 Metro Pace at Woodbine Mohawk Park, will ship back south to The Red Mile today (Oct. 5) to compete in the third and closing division of the \$300,900 International Stallion Stakes (ISS) for 2-year-old pacing colts and geldings.

Tony Alagna trains Fallout, a colt by Captaintreacherous and a full-brother to stakes winner Captain Kirk. Fallout had just one win on his card before heading to Canada for harness racing's richest race for freshman pacing males, in which he roared home as the 8-5 second choice to clock a lifetime-best mile of 1:49.1. Tim Tetrick stays with the 8-5 morning-line chalk who starts from post 4 against a field of nine in the afternoon's seventh race.

Today's card opens with the first division of the ISS colt pace, which will see Kentucky Championship Series winner Louprint return to the track. Listed on the morning line at 6-5, Louprint draws post 3 off a swooping victory in 1:48.4 to keep in tack his

mostly unblemished record; six wins from seven starts with one runner-up finish. Ronnie Wrenn, Jr. retains the drive behind the Sweet Lou colt for trainer Ron Burke as he'll face eight others including New York Sires Stakes champ Thirsty Thursday from post 2 as well as a pair of regally bred colts to the outside – Caviart Act Two, out of stakes-winner Caviart Ally, from post 8 and Strangerinthenight, out of stakes-winner Tall Drink Hanover, from post 9.

The middle ISS division for pacing colts has a 2-1 morning-line choice in Chris Ryder trainee American Son, who escapes Louprint after finishing third against him in the Kentucky Championship Series final. Dexter Dunn pilots the son of American Ideal from post 2, just to the inside of 7-2 second choice Banderas – a Tall Dark Stranger colt out of Breeders Crown winner Reflect With Me. James MacDonald keeps the drive on the Tony Alagna pupil after finishing fifth in the Metro Pace back on Sept. 21.

Champagne Problems fronts the first of five divisions for the \$342,000 ISS for 2-year-old trotting fillies. The Tactical Landing filly lands the pylon post as the even-money morning-line favorite following a 1:54 victory in the Jim Doherty Memorial at Harrah's Hoosier Park on Sept. 13. Dunn drives the Nancy Takter trainee in a field that includes New York Sires Stakes champ Royal Mission, who starts from post 3 after finishing third to Champagne Problems in the Jim Doherty Memorial. Scott Zeron drives the Chapter Seven full-sister to stakes-winners Slay and Ahundreddollarbill for trainer Marcus Melander.

World champion Atlanta's first foal, Deja Blu, looks to build on her four-race winning streak in the second ISS filly trot. The Takter-trained Muscle Hill filly makes her first start since



taking the \$100,000 Kentucky Commonwealth final as the 1-5 favorite on Sept. 15. Yannick Gingras drives the 7-5 morning line choice from post 6 against a bunch that features New Jersey Classic winner R Charm out of post 8 and Margareta Hanover, a Maharajah half-sister to champion Jiggy Jog S, from post 1.

Kentuckiana winner Kendra is the slight favorite in the third ISS division. The Walner filly popped the pocket to a dead-heat victory in the \$222,000 stake at Harrah's Hoosier Park on Sept. 20 and will get a new pilot in James MacDonald. Takter trains the filly who starts from post 6, just to the outside of Peaceful Way elimination winner R Dutchess and two slots inside of Luna Lovegood, Dunn's choice in the race for trainer Melander and a three-time preliminary winner in the Kentucky Championship Series.

A pair of big-price 2-year-olds land the outermost posts in the octet competing in the fourth ISS filly trot. Voguish, a Gimpanzee half-sister to millionaire Venerable who sold for \$535,000 last fall in Harrisburg, starts from post 7 and just to the inside of Kadena, an \$800,000 Lexington Selected purchase last fall and a filly by Gimpanzee out of world champion and current Red Mile track-record holder Mission Brief. Andy McCarthy will drive Voguish for trainer Andrew Harris off her dead-heat win with Kendra in the \$222,000 Kentuckiana Stakes while Dunn retains the assignment on Kadena for trainer Melander as she enters from a runner-up finish in the Kentucky Commonwealth final. The stacked fourth division also includes Kentucky Championship Series winner Aperfect Annie from post 6, who starts just to

the outside of 9-5 morning-line favorite Pink Chou Chou as she looks for her second win in her career.

Country Victory earns morning-line favoritism honors in the closing ISS split for trotting fillies. The Melvin Schmucker-trained daughter of International Moni makes her first start off a runner-up finish as the 1-5 chalk in the \$26,500 Standardbred Stakes at Delaware, OH, back on Sept. 18. Gingras picks up the drive from post 5 in the field of eight that also includes Spicy Nice, a Takter-trained filly by Tactical Landing out of stakeswinner Maven, starting from post 8 in rein to McCarthy.

Divisions 1 and 3 of the ISS 2-Year-Old Colt and Gelding Pace are named "The Tall Dark Stranger" and are sponsored by the Tall Dark Stranger Syndicate and Hanover Shoe Farms. The middle split is named "The Summa Cum Laude" and is sponsored by Midland Acres.

The first division of the ISS 2-Year-Old Filly Trot is named "The Norman Woolworth Memorial" and the fourth division is named "The Margareta Wallenius-Kleberg Memorial." Both are sponsored by Arden Homestead Stable, E. T. Gerry, Jr., Peter Gerry, Stoner Manor Inc., Menhammar Stuteri AB, Jorgen Jahre Jr., LST Stable, Lawrence DeVan and William DeVan. The second division is named "The Chapter Seven" and is sponsored by Blue Chip Farms, while divisions 3 and 5 are named "The International Moni" and are sponsored by the International Moni Syndicate and Hanover Shoe Farms.

Today's program features 15 races total. First-race post time is 1 p.m. (EDT).

Gruesome Twosome headlines quintet of Indiana Sire Stakes winners

The week of Indiana Sire Stakes action continued at Harrah's Hoosier Park on Thursday (Oct. 3) with the final leg for both the sophomore trotting colts and rookie pacing colts. Three \$46,500 divisions of the sixth leg for pacing colts took to the track, while a pair of divisions for trotting colts was highlighted by a triumphant return to the Hoosier State for **Gruesome Twosome**.

Returning from an appearance in the Canadian Trotting Classic at Mohawk in his last outing, Gruesome Twosome was tabbed at the 1-9 bettors' choice in his \$49,500 split. Trainer and driver Daryl Bontrager got away fifth in the field of six on the first turn with Gruesome Twosome as Raylan Drew (Mike Oosting) took the field to the guarter in :27.4. Gruesome Twosome did his best to follow the backstretch brush of Dashing Danny (Kyle Wilfong) who assumed command at the half in :57.2, while the favorite was now left first-over in third. Dashing Danny scampered away by two on the turn to reach three-quarters first in 1:26 as Gruesome Twosome moved into second on the outside, a touch on the right line on the final bend. Gruesome Twosome straightened out in the lane, powering home in :27.2 to get by Dashing Danny in deep stretch and reach the wire first 1¼ lengths in front of the divisional points leader in 1:53.4. Flirtnwiththepilot (Pete Wrenn) rallied for the show spot.

Bontrager also co-owns the son of You Know You Do—All Set Lets Go with Ira Steinberg. A winner in six of 10 in his sophomore campaign, Gruesome Twosome has earned \$174,978 this season and now over \$400,000 for his career following the victory.

The \$50,000 first division for trotting colts saw A Blue Million and driver Mike Peterson scamper up the passing lane to pull an 11-1 upset victory. The complexion of the race changed early as 4-5 favorite CS Flying Co-Pilot jumped it off behind the gate, meanwhile 20-1 shot Ira Who (Jared Finn) grabbed command through a lukewarm opening quarter of :29 with A Blue Million in the pocket. Ira Who had things his way to the half in :58.1 before 2-1 second-choice Winslow (Dan Shetler)

surged first-over to the outside of Ira Who entering the final turn, with the duo sprinting four lengths clear of A Blue Million to three-quarters in 1:26.3. Winslow had powered clear in the lane before going off-stride midway through the stretch, leaving A Blue Million and a closing Helpem Dance (Ricky Macomber, Jr.) to settle it amongst themselves. The two trotted to the wire together, with A Blue Million reaching the wire first by a neck in 1:55.2. Knowyoucando (Wilfong) recovered from an early break of his own to finish third.

Leander Schwartz trains the gelded son of Swan In A Million—IPO Blue Chip who has won six of 15 outings on the season. Owned by Jeffrey and Stephen Stoll, A Blue Million has made \$98,660 on the season and \$113,424 lifetime following his 11th career victory.

The 2-year-old colt pacers kicked off their stakes affairs on the evening with a price as well, with **Spirit And Heart** and Trace Tetrick scoring at 12-1. Leaving from post 4, Spirit And Heart quickly grabbed command of the field of eight to the quarter in :27.4 with 3-5 favorite Odds On Brahmastra (Wrenn) in the pocket. Unchallenged to the half in :56.4, Spirit And Heart paced 2½-lengths clear on the turn to three-quarters in 1:25. With both Odds On Brahmastra and Big Bad Moses (Macomber, Jr.) rallying to his inside, Spirit And Heart displayed both in the stretch, reaching the wire a neck in front of Odds On Brahmastra in 1:52.1.



A winner in four of seven this season, Spirit And Heart is owned and trained by Eli Schwartz. The son of Luck Be Withyou—So Long My Love was a \$4,000 yearling buy at last fall's Hoosier Classic and now sports earnings of \$43,000.

Form returned in the second division with **Chandler Bing** marching to his third-straight victory of the season with driver Jay Cross as the 1-5 favorite. Chandler Bing was a fired up fourth on the first turn as Hopeyaliketheshow (Tetrick) surged to an early lead to the opening quarter in :27.1. Cross fed Chandler Bing racetrack on the backstretch, but was briefly forced threewide as Odds On Anubis (Wrenn) squeezed out in front of the favorite before thundering to the front of the field at the half in :55.4. With his traffic troubles clearing entering the final turn, Cross turned Chandler Bing loose, powering around Odds On Anubis to the lead by 2½ lengths at three-quarters in 1:24. Building a 4½-length lead at the eighth-pole, Chandler Bing had enough cushion to fend off Hopeyaliketheshow who shook loose late by three-parts-of-a-length in 1:51.1. Derek's Rocket (LeWayne Miller) rallied for third at 64-1.

Trained by Alvin Miller, who co-owns with Twila Harts, Chander Bing has won half of his eight outings in his rookie campaign, banking \$91,790. The gelded son of Tellitlikeitis—Northern Beauty was bred by Glen Yoder and was a \$29,000 yearling buy at the Hoosier Classic.

Hall of Fame driver Yannick Gingras made the trip to Anderson well worth it, steering **Avanti** to victory in the third and final division for pacing colts. The 3-5 choice from post 2, Gingras guided Avanti into third early while The Family Man (Oosting) strayed from his usual late-closing tactics to cut the quarter in :26.4. Gingras brushed Avanti to the lead on the backstretch, however the freshman was a tad hesitant to clear before crossing back over to the pylons through a half of :56.2. Reaching three-quarters in 1:25, Avanti sprinted away in the lane, coasting to victory by 1½ lengths over The Family Man in 1:52. Special Pete (Miller) uncorked his usual stretch rally for the show spot.

Avanti entered the evening fresh off of a Grand Circuit score in his last, winning the \$100,000 Elevation on Sept. 20. Missy Essig trains the son of Rockin Image—Sayulita for owners Rocco Ruffolo and Fac Racing. A winner in three of 11 on the year, Avanti boasts earning of \$135,150.

Always Ana Hanover goes Keystone Classic record 1:51.1

Always Ana Hanover overwhelmed the leader, even-money favorite Pilar Hanover, with a powerful, uncovered backside move and rolled home in a stakes-record 1:51.1 in Thursday's (Oct. 3) Keystone Classic at Hollywood Casino at the Meadows. Royally Hot sprang a 12-1 upset in the other division of the stake for freshman filly pacers.

Always Ana Hanover was fourth when Ronnie Wrenn, Jr. sent her after Pilar Hanover, who offered resistance but succumbed in the stretch. The rallying Earth Angel was second, a half-length back, while 56-1 bomb Lyons Anitasangel earned show. The time is a career best for Always Ana Hanover and erased the previous stakes mark of 1:51.3 Caviart Cherie established in 2016.

"They went pretty good to the half, but it's always tough to come first over here and last," Wrenn said. "That was probably her best race of the year."

Ron Burke trains the daughter of Always B Miki—Ana Hanover for Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi LLC, William Switala and James Martin.

Royally Hot had won just once — and that in an overnight — but trainer Jim King, Jr. considered the Keystone Classic a good spot for her.

"She's been competitive right along," King said. "She's a little healthier right now than she's been. She hasn't really had her feelings hurt all year, which makes a difference at the end of the year."

Owner/breeder/driver Tim Tetrick moved the daughter of Bettor's Wish—McSauna from third past the three-quarters. She zipped by the leader, 1-9 favorite Beach Rules, and scored in 1:51.4, a new life mark. Blessed Hanover was second, beaten 1³/₄ lengths, while Lyons Benz completed the ticket at 61-1.

King indicated Royally Hot will race twice more in Pennsylvania stakes this year but has a more ambitious engagements schedule at 3.

Aaron Merriman, Dave Palone, Mike Wilder and Wrenn each enjoyed doubles on the 13-race card.
