Lexington Sale tops \$55 million, just \$1 million away from breaking all-time record

Through three days the gross is a record \$55.5 million — up \$9 million from last year — and the average is over \$95,000. With two sessions to go, the sale is just over \$1 million away from smashing last year's jaw-dropping gross total of \$56,687,500.

Records, records and more records fell Wednesday (Oct. 5) during the third session of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale at Fasiq-Tipton.

Through three days, the sale gross of \$55,494,000 is up 19 per cent from the previous record of \$46,609,000 set in 2021.

With two sessions to go, the sale is just over \$1 million away from smashing last year's jaw-dropping gross total of \$56,687,500.

This year's cumulative average of \$95,024 is a new sale standard and a record 189 yearlings have reached six-figure sale prices through three days — a record by a whopping 49 horses.



As for the third session alone, it smashed records for gross (\$11,994,000, up 18 per cent), average (\$51,038, up 11 per cent) for 235 yearlings sold and \$100,000+ yearlings (25, up five yearlings from last year).




Harness Racing Update

"For the last number of years, if you just look at the way the sessions are seeded... naturally the averages come down," said sale co-manager David Reid, who runs the sale with Randy Manges. "There's probably more of a blend of sires as we come down and the commercial value of the production of the mares, but we're making those decisions in the spring time and early summer so things can change. As a whole, it does trend down, but tonight's average is \$51,000 and that's nothing to sneeze at.

"(Thursday) night might trickle down just a little bit more, but it's all about the process and try to place the horses in the right spot. Randy and I are firm believes that if you put a horse in the wrong spot, you can be penalized for that so that's part of our job when we're dealing with our consignors is to try to seed the sale and place the horses to maximize the horse's value for all parties. Sometimes people have different opinions, but, at the end of the day, our goal is to have the best venue possible."

Trainer Tony Alagna, the sale's leading buyer, said the sale has been, "amazing. The book, to me, and the individuals we saw on the farms, they have played out exactly like we thought the sale would go. I didn't think there was a million-dollar horse or \$800,000 or \$900,000 horse, but I thought there were a lot of horses that were going to fall into that \$300,000 to \$500,000 range."

David Reid's Preferred Equine is the leading consignor with over \$10 million in gross sales.

Manges said, "It's a big plus that we've got the big crowds and with new people coming. It's very encouraging. I'm expecting (Thursday) to be a good day. I ran into some guys today and they hadn't been here in four years. They were Canadians and had been through three years of COVID, so it's good to see them. And they were active in the bidding. One guy didn't get any horses, so he'll be active tomorrow."

SESSION TOPPER BROUGHT \$250,000

The session topper was **Hip 528 Stella Volo**, a Six Pack filly out of No I'm Not purchased by Fred Kruszelnicki of Brooks, AB for \$250,000 from the Kentuckiana consignment.

"I was just interested in getting a trotting filly because I own some shares in trotting stallions and, down the road, I'd like to use her as a broodmare. I really loved the filly, so I came down to buy that filly," Kruszelnicki said, adding it will be the only yearling he will buy in Lexington.

"I just liked the way she looks, the way she moves, the way she's in the paddock... (Six Pack) was a great horse and he's got to have a shot."

Hip 396 Midwind Dolce, a Father Patrick filly out of Boccone Dolce, sold for \$215,000 to Euro Stall SE of Berlin, OH from the Peninsula Farm consignment.

ALAGNA REMAINS TOP BUYER

Through three sessions, trainer Alagna has spent \$3,014,000, total, to purchase 21 yearlings. He bought six more on Wednesday afternoon, spending \$545,000 to do so.

"We've got Stay Hungry that we supported heavily last year and he had a great year this year, first year out, so we're looking for more of those," Alagna said. "We're always going to support (Captaintreacherous). He's been very good to us and we always want to keep that going. We had a really good year with trotting fillies and some trotting colts,


so really wanted to get in on a couple of Greenshoes. I train a couple for Ken Jacobs and he bought a few very nice Walner colts. Then, basically, just filling orders for owners. Chapter Seven has been very good to us, so we stepped out on a couple of Chapter Sevens as well."

Alagna said his strategy for yearling shopping in Lexington will change a bit in the final two sessions.

"I think you're just a little more critical. We filled a lot of orders the first two days, but we also still continue to look because third day does not mean there's not nice horses in there, it's just that they are a little farther apart," he said. "We bought the brother to Stay Hungry [Hip 520 The Dragon Reborn] tonight and we gave \$100,000 for him. I thought that was a great buy. We bought two very nice Captain fillies from Brittany's consignment that we saw at the farm turned out. They are really nice fillies. [Hip 419 Gifted One, \$180,000; Hip 527 Ocean Way, \$100,000]."

PREFERRED TOPS \$10 MILLION

Preferred Equine has now surpassed \$10 million in sales through three days and sits atop the consignor leaderboard with exactly \$10,200,000, followed by Hunterton (\$8,712,000) and Kentuckiana (\$7,547,000). Preferred led all consignors in Wednesday's session with \$2,651,000 in sales for 51 yearlings.

"It was another solid night," said Reid, Preferred's owner. "We were strong with pacers tonight, sold a Stay Hungry really well, but right through we had regional sires, national sires. We had good luck with the pacing fillies tonight and the trotters have been holding strong."

Hanover Shoe Farms, which sold all of its yearlings the first two days, still leads in consignor average with \$194,174 for 23 yearlings. Hunterton is next (\$128,118 for 68), followed by All American (\$127,909 for 11).

WALNER LEADING ALL SIRES

Walner has a slight edge over Captaintreacherous in sire gross (\$6,899,000 to \$6,486,000, respectively) through three days. Chapter Seven is third with \$6,383,000 and Greenshoe is fourth with \$6,253,000. The Captain leads in sire average with \$154,429.

Manges said he expects the record-breaking trend to continue in today's fourth session, which begins at 2 p.m. and will feature 164 yearlings.

"We had a huge crowd (Wednesday). We had a lot of new people that came. I think it'll be decent (Thursday) and Friday," Manges said.

Dennis Bontrager realized a childhood dream selling a yearling in Lexington

As Premier First Star entered the sale ring more than five hours into Lexington Selected Yearling Sale's Wednesday session, Dennis Bontrager saw a childhood dream realized. Consigned as Hip 555, the Stay Hungry colt, first foal from Western Terror mare Royal Terror, brought \$37,000. Bontrager sat in the Fasig-Tipton Sales Pavilion to take in the experience of selling his first yearling at "the mecca" of fall auctions.

"I love it, absolutely love it," he said. "My heart was pumping. Adrenaline was high."

The dream of selling began at an early age while reading magazine coverage of the annual event.

"As a boy I always read *Hoof Beats* and saw the pictures. It fascinated me, just the facilities. It was always a dream to sometime find a mare of that caliber. And that happened. We finally made it," he said.

Despite his knowledge of harness racing, Bontrager is relatively new in standardbred breeding. The 40-year-old has made a living with warmbloods, particularly Morgan horses. He owns and operates Premier Acres in Middlebury, IN. The 70-acre facility serves as a stallion station, focusing on breeding and boarding.

"I would still say my heart is in the Morgan world. I've been involved in the Morgan breed for about 22 years. The way I got connected with that is through my stallion facilities. I stood 15 or 20 stallions at one time," Bontrager said. "I was asked to stand a couple of commercial Standardbred stallions, got hooked up with Tony Alagna, and I fell in love with harness horses."

Over the last five seasons, Premier Acres has slowly increased its presence in Indiana's standardbred breeding industry, adding stallions each season. The farm now stands six studs with a balanced offering for both gaits.

"On the trotting side we have You Know You Do, who is having a good season, and we have Pastor Stephen, and he is getting a good group of mares. He didn't breed a full book of mares, but we bred a lot of good mares. Pilot Discretion is selling his first crop at the Hoosier Classic this year and the hype is pretty high on those. I've talked to trainers and consignors and they like those, so we're excited to see that first crop come to the sale ring." he said.

You Know You Do's 2-year-old crop is led by Bourbon Courage, who has reached the winner's circle in Indiana and Kentucky, earning \$139,290 to date with a mark of 1:53.1.

Hip 555 Premier First Star, a son of Stay Hungry out of Royal Terror, sold for \$37,000 on Wednesday at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale. It was the first horse ever consigned at the Lexington sale by Dennis Bontrager.

"On the pacing side we have Odds On Equuleus. He has a small crop out there, but a very high success rate. His first crop produced Indiana Sire Stakes Super Final winner Trick Of The Light last season. We have Capt Midnight, who is going into his third year, but we had two full books of mares. We were full within six weeks after opening up. The demand is high on him,"

Not only did Dennis Bontrager sell his first horse at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale, he also met Hall of Fame trainer Jimmy Takter.

continued Bontrager. "We have a new horse that came in late last year that didn't make the stallion book, so we missed out on some advertising opportunities. His name is Best In Show. He's a Bettor's Delight that won the Meadowlands Pace. He's a very nice horse, put together well. We bred a little over 100 mares to him in his first year. We've very excited to have him as new blood in Indiana, a little outcross with Bettor's Delight."

As he dipped his toe into standing commercial stallions, Bontrager also purchased a few broodmares for the farm. He found Royal Terror on the **www.eharness.com** sale platform, acquiring her out of Canada in 2019. From the Matt's Scooter mare Her Mattjesty, the broodmare is a sister to 12 different winners, herself race timed in 1:56.2.

"When Tony came up a couple years ago for my open house with Pilot Discretion and Capt Midnight, I showed him the pedigree, and he said, 'You need to breed her to Stay Hungry. You know what, you're a good friend of mine, you can have one of my breedings. She'll work for Lexington.' That's what we did," Bontrager said.

Luck is a big part of the business, and Bontrager has had the good fortune of seeing significant updates on the pedigree of Premier First Star. The dam is a full sister to Dismissal, dam of sophomore pacer Bythemissal. As he has excelled in the Buckeye State, recently winning the Little Brown Jug, Bontrager's yearling has benefitted.

"I was fortunate because she's a full sister to the dam of Bythemissal, the Jug winner that is almost over a million dollars now," Bontrager commented. "That definitely helps my colt. He's got a deep pedigree, the second, third and fourth dams are deep. I was fortunate to find a mare like this."

Premier First Star was consigned as agent by Anvil And Lace Farm. Bontrager made the connection with Beth Yontz through

the farm's breeding facilities. He arrived in time to witness the fireworks Monday night, his first time on the Fasig-Tipton grounds. Wednesday afternoon he met and talked with Jimmy Takter at the Anvil And Lace consignment, chatting with the Hall of Fame trainer about the latter's former pupil, Pastor Stephen.


"The most enjoyable part was day one. It was just awesome sitting in there. Seeing them in person, going out and looking at them individually, it's priceless to me. Usually I just read about it. Being here in person, being a part of it, is just huge," he said.

The first 15 progeny from Stay Hungry that passed through the ring during the first three sessions averaged \$80,400, including a colt that brought \$240,000 Monday evening.

Anthony Beaton signed the ticket on Premier First Star. The colt's selling price didn't come near Stay Hungry's average, but that did not discourage his breeder.

"Beth wanted a little bit more, but I said, 'It's alright. I'll be back," he said. "I was hoping for a little bit more. I'm not disappointed at all. The Stay Hungrys are doing well, I thought he might bring a little bit more. I've been in the horse business, I know the ups and downs. He's in good hands and he'll have a shot, that's the main thing."








Smooth sale-ing for Greenshoe despite the Gural Rule

Maybe the rules don't apply to Greenshoe, at least where sales are concerned.

Prior to the start of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale on Monday (Oct. 3), there was discussion as to whether the Stallion Restriction Condition (SRC), better known as the "Gural Rule", would have an effect on how the Greenshoe yearlings would sell.

"I don't think it will have any significant affect," said Bob Boni, whose Northwood Bloodstock consignment in Lexington sold two by Greenshoe. "If there's a right-looking Greenshoe in the ring, they'll sell fine. A couple of years ago, you had the same thing with Downbytheseaside that wasn't eligible. And I don't think somebody who wanted one that was going to spend \$100,000 looked at it and said, I'll only go \$75,000. You saw similar with Bar Hopping."

Owner Mark Weaver has firsthand experience when it comes to dealing with the SRC, which according to the rule says: "This condition applies to sires and their foals conceived when the sire is 4 years old, it does not apply to sires or their foals if

the foal is conceived when the sire is 5 years old or older." Exemptions are possible if certain criteria are met.

"When we bought a lot of the Downbytheseasides it never crossed my mind," said Weaver.

On April 1, 2022, the tag team of Weaver and Mike Bruscemi became co-owners of Bythemissal, with Burke Racing, Good and Lombardo Racing, from the first crop of Downbytheseaside.

Bythemissal is currently the top-ranked 3-year-old male pacer in the Hambletonian Society/Breeders Crown weekly Top 10 poll, and has seasonal earnings of \$980,525 without ever competing at The Meadowlands.

"When we bought him, to me, it didn't really hurt his value much," said Weaver referring to the SRC.

No one can question Gural's good intentions by wanting to keep older stars on the track, to help create new fans as well as bring them and existing ones out to the races, when he introduced the rule in 2011. It was originally envisioned as a lifetime ban from The Meadowlands, Vernon Downs and Tioga Downs, and included baby races, qualifiers, stakes and overnights, but was later changed to just stakes events.

For a short time, both the Hambletonian Society and Woodbine Entertainment Group (WEG) backed the Gural Rule, but since 2015, The Meadowlands has stood alone, prompting one to question: Is the rule accomplishing what it was created to do?

"I understand what the rule is intended to do. I just don't know if it penalizes the people that it's supposed to," said Weaver. "It penalizes the most the people that put the rule in place. It's done by The Meadowlands and for the fans and I think the people it penalizes the most is The Meadowlands and the fans. It's not designed to have the impact that they want it to.

"You can't tell me that having Pebble Beach, that had just beaten Beach Glass, and Bythemissal, who beat Beach Glass in the Adios, wouldn't have made for a better Meadowlands Pace. By doing it, he's keeping stars off the track."

Earlier this year, the SRC was revised to allow ineligible first-crop foals to race as 4-year-olds and up.

"The spirit of the rule is to try and keep our stars racing, so excluding older horses from our stakes was not our intention," said Gural in a February Meadowlands' press release. "There are some horses returning to the races from age 3 to 4 this year that are of the quality that we'd like to see continue to race. This had not previously been considered and needs to be corrected rather than exclude those horses by the SRC."

Since Gural has revised the rule before, perhaps he would be open to one suggested update that could be a win for The Big M and the fans.

In a time when every track is fighting for horses, wouldn't it benefit The Meadowlands to change the SRC to allow the first-crop horses to race but penalize them by charging them more?

If those currently ineligible 2-year-olds and 3-year-olds had to pay double or triple the staking fees, wouldn't that be enough of a penalty to the stallion yet also be beneficial to The Meadowlands by making more money through staking, having larger fields and the best competitors on the track?

When asked if it had been an option, would he have considered paying twice as much to put Bythemissal into the Pace, Weaver said: "We just paid \$45,000 to race him in the Jug. We plan on spending \$62,000 to put him in the Breeders Crown."

As for the effect on Greenshoe in the Lexington Sale, he was the leading sire in session No. 1 with \$4,132,000 in total sales and had the \$500,000 topper for session No. 2.

"Would it be nice to be eligible?" said Boni. "Sure, it would, but I don't think it has any significant impact on what they'll sell for. Greenshoe was as talented as any trotter you'd ever want to see and that's what's going to sell his foals."

As Bulldog Hanover continues to make history, a colorful look at the sport's major speed records

If you watched the Aaron Judge home run chase you likely knew all about the history of the home run record. If you are at the World Series Game 7 You more than likely know the amount of championships your team has won prior. If you are at the Masters, you know history is likely just around the corner.

Same with Sunday Oct. 9, 2022. Bulldog Hanover.

In order to more fully appreciate what this incredible horse has done and what still might come, here's a colorful look at the speed records from 1897, when the first sub-2:00 mile was posted just four years after the start of the Kentucky Futurity.

In 1897, **Star Pointer** was simply not on his game pre-time trial. He was sluggish his first warmup trip and broke his second. But, they turned and went anyway and he posted a 1:59.1/4 new all-time best. There was a band present and they played "Hail To The Chief." Driver Dave McClary was hoisted up on the fans shoulders and paraded around.

Dan Patch. Four times he would lower this mark and then the world had to wait another 33 years!

In 1903, big crowds were the norm for Dan Patch. He was the attraction and many would say the biggest sports star of the first decade of the 20th century. or even longer. Myron McHenry time trialed him in 1:59 in 1903, then again the same year in 1:56.1 in Memphis, TN. He would take that down a tick to 1:56 flat in 1904.

In 1905, Harry Hersey set the new all-time mark of 1:55.1 with the now 9-year-old Dan Patch on Oct. 5, 1905 at The Red Mile. Prompters were called "pacemakers" then. Fractions were :29.1/2, :57.1/2. 1:26.1/4 and 1:55.1/4.

He raced at the Minnesota State Fair in 1906 and lowered it another fifth, but not officially as the sport didn't allow the use

of "windshields". So it would be over three decades before that number was actually reached.

1938 **Billy Direct** with Vic Fleming. The same week that Greyhound set his trotting mark (1:55.1/4) that would hold for 31 years, Billy Direct posted a 1:55 time trial. John Hervey summed it up best, "Without warning and without any special preparation for a record breaking attempt." Billy Direct lived only another decade, but he sired the great Tar Heel.

1955 **Adios Harry**, a son of the 15-year-old stallion sensation Adios, was sold as Hip #951. Luther Lyons was his trainer/driver. He took his mark in a race — the \$26,000 American Pacing Derby at Vernon Downs on July 16, 1955. A January 29, 1951 foal, the 4-year-old invoked this kind of response from the *Horseman and Fair World*, "No contest. He was never as much as shaken up and won by 8 and a half lengths." Adios Harry set 13 world race records in his career at various distances.

Adios was at it again five years later and with the first Horse of the Year to do so — **Adios Butler** in 1:54.3 lowering the mark for the first time in 22 years. Paige West handled him while Eddie Cobb his trainer was the prompter that made it. The other quit from exhaustion at the 5/8ths. Defending HOY Bye Bye Byrd tried time trialing earlier that day and won in 1:56.1, but not enough for a new all-time standard. They would go 1-2 in the 1960 HOY balloting. Fractions were :29,:56.2,1:25.3,1:54.3 at the Red Mile on Oct. 4,1960. Interesting that Bullet Hanover had set a world record earlier that week of 1:56.1 for sophomores, and he too tried time trialing. He came closer than Bye Bye Byrd at 1:55.3.



Bret Hanover lowered the mark twice to 1:54 then to 1:53.3. He might have had a home field advantage of sorts — 62-year-old Frank Ervin's barn was 150 yards from the draw gate at the Red Mile. Bret Hanover had worked a 1:56.2 mile on Monday and Ervin wanted to time trial on Saturday. But, the weather forecast was ominous for Saturday so they went Friday. Ike Bailey and Del Miller were the prompters with Miller joining the party just past the half mile pole. The three-time HOY set fractions of :27.4, :55.2, 1:24 and only had to come home in sub-30 for the successful try. He did. 1:53.3.

Steady Star. He may be the oddest member of this elite group. He simply was not a great horse. Many felt even less than very good. But, he did time trial as a 3-year-old in 1970 in 1:54.4 and no one knew how to time trial quite like Joe O'Brien. His career numbers of \$131,000 on the strength of 51 20-9-5 notwithstanding, he set a new mark of 1:52 at The Red Mile on Oct. 1, 1971. Not many thought this would hold nine years.

Niatross on Oct. 1, 1980. Sixteen world records. Clint Galbraith and Elsie Berger homebred. Two time HOY winner of the sport's first ever million-dollar race and the first ever \$2 million winner career. He time trialed in 1:49.1 that day at Lexington electrifying the harness world. It would be five years until his first crop yielded **Nihilator** — the first sub-1:50 in a race — and eight years until his time trial was lowered to 1:48.2 by **Matts Scooter** in 1988. Niatross' first crop saw him bred to an elite group of mares than included six world champions and nine national seasons champions.

Matts Scooter did this-1:48.2 before he was named HOY in 1989. He was 3YOCP of 1988 and a dominant force his entire career. He is the grandsire of Somebeachsomewhere who set his lifetime mark at the Red Mile in the early fall of 2008 - 1:46.4.

Cambest 1:46.1 Time trail of 1993 at DuQuoin with Bill O'Donnell driving. His individual quarters were :26.1, :25.3, :27.1, :27.1. He raced early on in his career for Dan Altmeyer and Dave Rankin. Later Fred Grant. Out of a Harold J mare Oxford Mary Ann. O'Donnell had set the racing mark of 1:48.2 with HOY Staying Together at the Meadowlands in the Driscoll/Haughton.

Always B Miki 1:46 at the Red Mile in 2016 – :26.1 last quarter to just edge by Cambest. The fastest race ever.


Lather Up 1:46 at the Meadowlands in 2019. Montrell Teague who already had a HOY with Wiggle It Jiggleit was back for more.

FIVE IN A ROW FOR BAZIRE

French top driver and trainer Jean-Michel Bazire went to the racetrack in Laval on Wednesday (Oct. 5) afternoon when the \$100,000 Grand Prix Anjou-Maine was on the race card and he had a title to defend. As a matter of fact, Bazire had claimed the trophy in Laval four years in a row before Wednesday's race and he entered the track as first choice behind his weapon Elie de Beaufour.

Elie de Beaufour (Royal Dream) started with 25 meters disadvantage, but Jean-Michel Bazire found the successful path to victory with his 8-year-old gelding.

Elie de Beaufour attacked from second over in the last turn and the home stretch became a battle between leader Hatchet Man and the outside trotter Elie de Beaufour. The latter held his head first at the wire and Jean-Michel Bazire can now look back at five straight wins in Laval's big race.

Mile rate was 1:57.2 over 1.7 miles and Bazire's previous winner the past four years are Aubrion du Gers, Cleangame, Dreambraker and Cleangame.

Bazire won the race for the first time in 2005, with Jardy and on three further occasions he has claimed the title in Laval. So, Wednesday's triumph meant that Bazire now has won the race nine times.





Jack Darling, Gilles Gendron, Frank Salive and Shadow Play to Canadian Hall of Fame

Trainer Jack Darling, veteran horseman Gilles Gendron, communicator Frank Salive and male horse Shadow Play are the standardbred inductees to the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame's class of 2022 to be inducted in 2023.

JACK DARLING

Cambridge, ON-based Jack Darling has enjoyed a successful career as a harness horse trainer in southern Ontario over three decades campaigning 1,072 winners and conditioning horses to over \$22 million in earnings and counting. For the first two decades of his career Darling focused on overnight horses, before getting involved in the yearling business. In 1995, four fillies put Darling in the spotlight - Diamond Dawn, a winner of \$175,000, Low Places (winner of a 1996 O'Brien Award), Faded Glory (winner of more than \$250,000 as a freshman) and Diehard Fan (over \$200,000 as a 2- and 3-year-old). Other top horses included Northern Luck (\$907,984), North America Cup champion Gothic Dream (\$1,528,671) and Twin B Champ (\$437,235). Darling's latest protégé, Bulldog Hanover, recently set a new world record of 1:45.4 to become the fastest horse in harness racing history and has to date earned nearly \$2.2 million. Darling is also known for significant fundraising efforts on behalf of racing related causes and was the 2015 winner of the Lloyd Chisholm Memorial Award, presented by the Standardbred Breeders of Ontario, the United States Harness Writers Association Unsung Hero Award, and the Good Guy Award.

GILLES GENDRON

Gilles Gendron of Saint-Eustache, QC, started his illustrious driving career in the spring of 1967 at the age of 22. During his career, he drove in more than 37,000 races, posted 7,053 victories, finished second in 5,008 starts and recorded 4,819 thirds. He drove horses to earnings in excess of \$36.9 million. Gendron was the dominant driver at Blue Bonnets racetrack during the 1970s and 1980s. At age 27 in 1972, Gendron won the Challenge of Champions hosted by Windsor Raceway, defeating the likes of Herve Filion, Ronnie Feagan and Carmine Abbatiello. Nicknamed "Le Chef", he dominated the Blue Bonnets driving charts, leading the driving



standings 10 times between 1972 and 1984. For 14 consecutive years, he won more than 200 races and ranked in the North American top 10 seven times. Among the equine stars he drove were Hall of Famers Grades Singing and Garland Lobell. In 2009, he drove a pair of winners at Rideau Carleton to put him at 7,000 career wins to join Quebec natives Herve Filion, Michel Lachance and Luc Ouellette in the select group of North American drivers who had posted 7,000 career wins.

FRANK SALIVE

Originally from Leamington, ON, Frank Salive was known for over 35 years as "The Voice" of Canadian harness racing. Before moving to the announcer's booth, Salive was a successful junior hockey player as part of the Peterborough Petes and also participated in the very first World Junior Championships when the Petes represented Canada in the 1974 tournament held in the Soviet Union. Canada earned the bronze medal and Salive was named the top goaltender of the tournament. He then moved on to a broadcasting career, which included assignments in Sudbury and Windsor, where he began to call harness races in the late 1970's. He continued at tracks throughout Ontario and the U.S., including 14 years at Ontario Jockey Club/Woodbine Entertainment Group harness tracks as well as at Pompano Park, Western Fair Raceway, Clinton Raceway and Fort Erie Racetrack before his most recent role as the voice of Ocean Downs in Maryland. During his career it is estimated Salive has called

close to 200,000 races at an estimated 75 different tracks. becoming a fan and industry favourite for his knowledgeable, informative calls and silky voice. Salive was also a regular writer for the Canadian Sportsman for several years.

SHADOW PLAY

Shadow Play earned \$1,559,822 with 20 wins, nine seconds and five thirds in 49 lifetime starts, and took a record of 1:47.4 as a 4-year-old. The son of The Panderosa, out of the Matts Scooter mare Matts Filly was purchased as a yearling, trained and co-owned by Dr. Ian Moore along with R G McGroup Ltd. and Serge Savard for most of his racing career. His race career highlights include winning the 2008 Little Brown Jug and setting a world record for 3-year-old colt and gelding pacers on a 5/8-mile track, of 1:48-2/5ths in the Elimination of the Coors Delvin Miller Adios.

As a sire standing at Winbak Farm of Canada, in partnership with Blue Chip Farms, and owned by the Shadow Play Syndicate, Shadow Play has sired six millionaires, including the fastest standardbred in harness racing history, Bulldog Hanover (1.45.4) with earnings to date of nearly \$2.2 million; three-time O'Brien Award winner and double millionaire Lady Shadow; 2021 Horse of the Year and North America Cup winner, Desperate Man; and O'Brien divisional winner, Percy Bluechip. In total Shadow Play sired horses have earned \$56 million. Twenty horses sired by Shadow Play have records of 1:50 or better.

Duly Resolved capped off his Ontario Sires Stakes season in style tonight by establishing a new trotting track record at The Raceway at the Western Fair District in one of two divisions for 3-year-old colts and geldings.

The son of Resolve was flawless start to finish, trotting a mile in 1:55.4 to earn the John Bax trainee the winner's share of the \$102,200 purse.

"It's an extra feather in his cap," said assistant trainer Matt Bax. "He's such a nice horse, and to have his name written down as the track record for all the owners that's pretty special."

Seven sophomore trotters were behind the gate in race three, and Duly Resolved and Paul Macdonell wasted no time getting ahead of six of them, cutting the first quarter mile in :28 to lead by a length over pocket sitter Star Power Hanover and Samuel Filion.

Jody Jamieson moved 2-1 second choice Red Overbach first up through the second panel but was unable to clear Duly Resolved who continued to lead through middle sections of :58.2 and 1:26.4.

Through three-quarters Duly Resolved led by a length over a parked out Red Overbach, and when Star Power Hanover made a break around the final turn, Macdonell and Duly Resolved were unchallenged the rest of the way, trotting home in :29 to best the existing trotting track record of 1:56 by over half of a second.

"He's always trained down on a half mile track, so we knew that he was going to be good," said Bax. "Paul said tonight that the faster he was around the turns, the more he leaned in, and he could fly around there. When you can fly around the turns on half-mile racing, you're pretty set." Duly Resolved was a standout 2-year-old, winning three times at the Gold level and finishing runner-up in the William Wellwood, Mohawk Million, and OSS Super Final to earn \$631,659 for his owners Bax Stable, David Hudson (Dallas, TX), Don Allensen (Wyoming, ON) Gaelic Stable (Sharon, ON).

He won the third start of his three-year-old campaign in May against OSS Gold company at Woodbine Mohawk Park but failed to finish in the top-three through July and August against OSS, open stakes, or overnight competition.

The tide started to shift with a promising second in the Simcoe on Sept. 3.

"We've been battling allergies all summer, and it doesn't seem to matter what kind of allergy medication you give him, just couldn't win that battle" said Bax. "But over the last month there I saw this huge shift in him and he's back to his old self, the way he was last year, so we're really rounding into form at the right time."

The \$225,000 Super Final is Oct. 15 at Woodbine Mohawk Park, where Duly Resolved will be looking to avenge his runner-up finish last season.

"I think his chances are pretty good, and just as good as anyone else's," said Bax.

Duly Resolved paid \$4.50 for the win.

The second \$102,200 Gold division was won by 25-1 longshot **Promise For Life** with Bruce Richardson driving for trainer Rene Dion.

The race began with odds-on favourite Safe Conduct and Chris Christoforou surging to the lead from post two, but Jody Jamieson was intent on challenging with 9-5 second choice Unevergonnagethis, and the pair dueled on the lead through a blazing :27.2 first quarter.

Promise For Life was well back in seventh and parked on the outside through panels of :56.3 and 1:26.1. Royalty Beer went first up to challenge the leaders and was abreast of them entering the stretch.

But Promise For Life and Richardson continued their charge that began before three-quarters and flew four wide down the lane to win in 1:56.3.

The Royalty For Life colt is owned by R A W Equine Inc. of Burlington, ON. and Acton, ON. S&r Racing Stable Inc.
