Lexington sale tops \$60 million for first time

During last year's fourth session of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale, the auction broke the \$50 million barrier for the first time in its history. On Thursday afternoon (Oct. 6) at Fasig-Tipton during this year's fourth session, **the sale broke the \$60 million mark** soaring right past the 2021 complete sale record of \$56,687,500. And there's still tonight's final yearling session to come.

"That's a huge accomplishment," said sale co-manager David Reid. "We're going into (Friday) night with guns loaded. I think we're going to have a good, solid night. Everyone is looking forward to it and we've got a lot of Downbytheseasides, so you can't be that wrong. In addition, you've got regional trotters and other regional sires as well. We've got the first crop of Lather Up, which should create a little bit of excitement. I have a couple of them myself to sell. Any time you can offer something new into a sale, then we're always looking forward to that."

The fourth session set records for gross (\$4,946,000, up 3.7 per cent), average (\$30,159, up 4.3 per cent) for 164 sold and median (\$26,000, up 4 per cent).

Through four days, the sale is averaging a record \$80,802, up 12 per cent from last year's four-day average of \$71,898. The median through four days is \$51,000. Last year it was \$47,000 at this point in the sale.

"When we crunch the numbers at the end and look through each session, I think probably the greatest gains we had... obviously, we sold more horses for \$100,000, but I think the median is going to be the key indicator," Reid said. "We didn't sell a horse for a million dollars and (Thursday) we didn't sell a horse for \$100,000, even though cumulatively we've sold 30 more than we did last year, I think you're going to see the greatest strength in the middle.

"Without having a \$100,000 yearling, it was kind of almost like the first night when we had a strong median and I think the strength is through the middle, which we talked about and that goes back to the depth of the catalogue," Reid said.

The session topper was **Hip 635 Amsterdam**, a Sweet Lou filly out of Someomensomewhere purchased for \$90,000 by Amanda Fine, agent, from Diamond Creek.

Hip 764 Oaks In Kountry, a Chapter Seven filly out of Whispering Oaks sold for \$82,000 out of the Anvil And Lace consignment. to M & L of Delaware's Douglas Paul said he made the purchase on behalf of Alabama Harness Asso.

"It's their second year in the business and they wanted all trotters this year. Jim McLean and Rita Armitrage are the Alabama Harness. It's a husband and wife. They seem to really like it," Paul said. "They just left maybe two hours before and gave me a budget of \$75,000 to buy that horse. I knew he'd be upset if I didn't pay a little bit more, so I bought it for \$82,000."

Hip 748 Tactical Strike, a Tactical Landing filly out of Sorceress Seelster, sold for \$80,000 to Gino Toscani of Ontario from the Hunterton consignment. Toscani has purchased 33 yearlings in Lexington this year and has spent \$1,448,000 to do so. He bought three on day one, nine on day two, 11 on day three and 10 on Thursday. He was the leading buyer in the fourth session with \$389,000 spent.

"We got a lot of variety, Muscle Hills, Walners, a lot of trotters, some pacers. We try to keep a mix. It was a good catalogue. I found the second and third days were as strong as the first. Even the fourth day, it was a good catalogue," Toscani said. "It's just a side thing that I've been doing for about 35 years. I drive and I train some. I'm in the house building business in Canada.

Harness Racing Update

"I figured I probably wouldn't be going to Harrisburg. I'm already at the sale, so I may as well just buy them here. They are just as well-bred. I'll skip the other sales this year.

"I have three trainers and myself as well."

Preferred Equine continues to lead all consignors in gross sales with \$10,862,000 made. On Thursday, Preferred (\$662,000) was second to Kentuckiana (\$742,000) in session sales.

"We had a little bit of everything," Reid said of Preferred's Thursday offerings. "We sold a pacing filly for \$72,000. We sold a pacing colt for \$40,000 or \$50,000. Solid through the middle. Some of the ones that came in on the low end... things happen and you just have to get them sold and moved. We had a great clearance rate, no buy backs, so from that point of view the whole week has been smooth that way. It's been a very clean sale.

"We've got some good offerings (Friday) night. We have an Illinois sire, we have a couple Indiana sires and some Ohio sires, so we have a good selection. I think we're selling 11 and we're looking forward to it.

"I think it's important for the regional programs to have a night and it makes them stand out a little bit. Nothing against any other organization or sales facility, but you're in Lexington and there's going to be great racing tomorrow, Saturday and Sunday. You can come down here and get the great Lexington experience. It's just really something special."


HUNTERTON TOPS \$9 MILLION

On Thursday, second-leading consignor Hunterton topped \$9 million and ended the day with sales of \$9,153,000 through all four sessions.

"That's pretty crazy, isn't it?" Hunterton's Steve Stewart said. "People always ask what your number is and we never even go there. We base everything on individuals, but most of the individuals have sold very, very well.

"We sold a Tactical Landing today and the owner was hoping for \$40,000 and he got \$80,000. It's been that type of sale. The first night is always crazy because you have a lot of wealthy people who want to buy what are perceived as the best horses in the sale. It always seems like that is strong because those people have a lot of money and a lot of them have done well, but once you get into the third and fourth sessions, I think it's showing how strong the purse structure in the industry really is, top to bottom.

"All people have to do is find a good horse and they'll make money. Now, that's not easy sometimes, but they know if they can pick out the right horse, they'll make money. I don't think it was always that way. Every jurisdiction is doing well and I'm sure most people are saying that it's very difficult to find a good racehorse because people are racing for too much money. They are racing for enough money that they don't have to sell. I really believe we are living in a golden time – usually we don't say it while it's happening — but I think we're living in a golden age

of harness racing. The purses have never been so good. It's not like we've flooded the market with too many horses and it's a very good time to be breeding horses."

ALAGNA STILL LEADS BUYERS, WALNER LEADS SIRES

Trainer Tony Alagna didn't buy any horses on Thursday, but he still leads all buyers with over \$3 million spent overall to purchase 21 yearlings.

Doug Overhiser is in second spot with \$2,223,000 spent to get 18 yearlings. The Andy Miller Stable is third with \$2,142,000 spent.

Walner still leads all sires, with gross sales of \$6,949,000. Tactical Landing was the leading sire in the fourth session with \$578,000 in sales for 17 yearlings.

Tonight's fifth and final session of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale will feature 138 yearlings mostly from Ohio and Indiana. It begins at 7 p.m. at Fasig-Tipton.

Linedrive Hanover sidelined for remainder of 2022 season

Focus is now on a 2023 comeback for top 4-year-old pacer.

The 2022 Major League Baseball postseason begins tonight (Oct. 7), but the harness horse with the baseball name has already called it a year. On Thursday (Oct. 6), trainer Anthony Beaton confirmed that Linedrive Hanover (p, 4, 1:49.0h; \$302,567) will not return to the races before 2023.

The anticipated rematch between Bulldog Hanover and Canada's fastest-ever pacer on a half-mile track is unlikely to materialize: The former, a world champion stallion, is expected to return to stud on a full-time basis next year, and Linedrive Hanover will miss the 2022 Breeders Crown at his home track, Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Speaking from Lexington, Beaton told HRU the reason racing fans haven't seen Linedrive since his July 23 show finish in the Joe Gerrity Jr. Memorial at Saratoga: "We shut him down after Saratoga...The couple of starts at The Meadowlands caught up to him. He's had his issues in the past, and they started to catch up to him."

The Betting Line—Lillian Hanover gelding fractured a tibia at age 3, slowing down an already-slow beginning to his racing career.

Connections agreed to give the late-blooming gelding some time off following his third-place effort as beaten favorite in the Gerrity.

"Sometimes you've just got to bite the bullet," said Beaton. "We said, 'Maybe we'll shut him down and see if we can bring him back a little later and prep for the Breeders Crown, and focus on that."

What was supposed to be a short layoff soon turned into a longer-term recovery for Linedrive Hanover.

"Once we did shut him down, we had him x-rayed and the bone bruising that he had at two caught up to him, so the ownership



group decided they were just going to shut him down for the rest of the year."

Linedrive Hanover was sent to Kentucky.

"As it turns out, we did find a little chip in that one ankle, behind, so he actually just had surgery here the other day in Lexington," Beaton told HRU. "We got it removed. We did have to put a couple of screws in his hind ankle. The bone bruising was getting that bad that he was starting to get some cysts in there."

Familiar with Linedrive Hanover's past issues, Dr. John Cummins recommended Kentucky Equine Hospital colleague and co-owner Dr. Wes Sutter perform the operation.

"I think Kentucky's ahead of the game and he's in great hands down here," said Beaton. "If there's ever anything major that we need to find out with Linedrive, we always forward his x-rays to Dr. Cummins and he was one of our go-to guys. Obviously Dr. Malone did a great job up in Canada to keep him going as long as he did. We're very fortunate. In January, we had a maiden; in July, we were pacing in 1:46.

"We're just trying to do the right thing for the horse," said the Puslinch, ON-based trainer. "Our game plan with him is to bring him back to Classy Lane [Stable Training Centre] in January and we're going to swim him, and I'll train him back for the owners... We're not going to rush him back... I think we do have a great horse on our hands. It's just a matter of keeping him sound and healthy."

There won't be another showdown with his best-known rival.

"That's one thing we can look forward to next year: We don't have to deal with Bulldog," said Beaton, laughing.

Linedrive Hanover was the last horse to defeat the sport's fastest-ever pacer, going gate-to-wire for James MacDonald May 22 in the Charles Juravinski Memorial final at Flamboro Downs. Bulldog Hanover went first over as the 7-5 favorite that race, never clearing; Linedrive Hanover held off a late move from O'Brien 2021 Horse of the Year Desperate Man, lowering Flamboro's track record to 1:49 – still the fastest mile this year by a 4-year-old gelding on a North American half.

"I didn't know what James' plan was that night," said Beaton. "I just handed him over the lines and said, 'Good luck, Let's get what we can get.' I knew we were going to have to go a big mile. Did I expect to be on the front end? No.

"It was a little rivalry for sure, because actually Jack Darling is at the end of my shedrow, and Bulldog was like two or three stalls down from Linedrive," Beaton said. "We were pulling the shoes on Linedrive there before he went to Kentucky. The blacksmith took him up to his shop and coincidentally enough, he's got two stalls and Bulldog was on one side, Linedrive on the other. He got pictures of it."

After the Gerrity, Linedrive Hanover needed time off.

"He came out of that race very sore. We had just four or five weeks to get him ready for the Canadian Pacing Derby, which was our next thing on the schedule," Beaton said. The pacer's 2022 campaign was put on hold after July.

"He just had the surgery the other day, so he's on stall rest right now in Lexington," said the trainer. "I don't know what our timeline will be, as far as his first start back goes. We're not going to rush him. He's going to tell us when he's ready.



He'll be in Kentucky until January: At Dr. Cummins' for the next little bit, then he's going to move over to Anvil and Lace [Farm in Cynthiana, KY]."

His comeback will likely be at Woodbine Mohawk Park in early 2023. Linedrive Hanover's runner-up finish, a nose behind Jimmy Freight in the June 18 Mohawk Gold Cup Invitational, was one of the gelding's best performances this year.

"That was definitely one of them," Beaton said," but that horse has never had a bad start for me... It's just awesome to have him under my care. I have to thank the ownership for trusting a guy to have a horse like that."

Linedrive Hanover is owned by West Wins Stable, Wellington, FL; McKinlay and Fielding, Toronto, ON; and Mac Nichol, Burlington, ON.

Beaton had purchased four yearlings at Lexington at the time of his interview. He said he had looked at, but not purchased, Hip 250 Legendary Hanover. The Huntsville half-brother to Linedrive brought a top bid of \$260,000, "a little more than my budget." As with Linedrive Hanover, the colt will begin his career with trainer Casie Coleman of Wellington, FL, so Beaton said he's hopeful he might one day get to train him in Canada.

"That would be awesome. I was very interested in the horse."

It's understandable, given all the upside to Linedrive Hanover.

"He just doesn't seem to get tired," Beaton said. "He's got a great set of lungs on him. He's very efficient-gaited. He's got

the qualities of a good horse. He's actually pretty easy-going. He likes attention. He's always pawing at the gate and whatnot. We do tend to maybe cater to him a little more. He might get that extra carrot or banana."


Riley Murphy was caretaker to Linedrive Hanover before the gelding left for Kentucky.

"He took over the care of him and he's done a wonderful job with him."

With a seasonal record of 11 wins in 17 starts, only missing the board once in his first full year of racing, the former \$75,000 Harrisburg yearling rapidly made up for lost time in 2022.

"Linedrive, he's not going to back down from anybody," said Beaton. "The big thing was the Juravinski, but we had other great memories: The win streak, going to The Meadowlands. I got to race my first horse, as a trainer myself, at The Meadowlands this year and I got to go to Saratoga to race him, which was probably one of the highlights... When he went out on the track, he left everything out there."







Week two of Lexington Grand Circuit starts today

The final week of the stakes session at Red Mile is set to begin this afternoon (Oct. 7) with three divisions of the \$290,400 International Stallion Stakes, for freshman trotting colts and geldings, and two divisions of the \$253,000 Perfect Sting International Stallion Stakes, for freshman pacing fillies.


Freshman trotting colts and geldings open Friday's action with the \$96,800 Muscle Hill. Following a sick scratch last week, Peter Haughton champ Kilmister will return to Lexington but this time will start from post 7 after drawing no wider than post 2 in six of his seven starts. Brian Sears drives the Marcus Melander trainee against six others all returning off starts in the Bluegrass Stakes, including third-place finishers Excalibur Bi (starting from post 3) and Purple Lord (post 6).

Division two for the trotting colts and geldings goes as the \$96,800 Six Pack International Stallion Stakes. Gates Hanover lands post 4 for trainer-driver Ake Svanstedt off a 1:52.3 win in the Bluegrass Stakes and starts just two draws inside of Tony Alagna trainee Ari Ferrari J (post 6), who acquires the hands of David Miller after a 1:54.2 win in the Bluegrass. Dexter Dunn, the regular pilot of both Bluegrass winners, opted to steer Domenico Cecere trainee Winner's Bet (post 3), the winner of the William Wellwood Memorial who will try to regain footing after breaking stride in the stretch of the Mohawk Million.

Last of the freshman trotting colt and gelding contests goes as Race 7, dubbed the \$96,800 Chapter Seven International Stallion Stakes. Espresso will look to live to billing off a 22-1 win in the Bluegrass from post 8, and this time scores a better draw from post 2 with Andy Miller at the helm of the Julie Miller trainee. Crown will compete from post 6 with Brian Sears in the bike as he rematches Espresso after finishing second from an off-the-pace trip.

Action for the freshman pacing fillies begins in Race 6 with all attention on Twin B Joe Fresh. Chris Ryder's speedy project leaves from post 7 in rein to Dexter Dunn as she once again faces Strong Poison, who has finished behind Twin B Joe Fresh on numerous occasions and now exits a

1:51.3 win in the Bluegrass last week. Yannick Gingras drives Strong Poison out of post 3 for trainer Ron Burke.

Race 9 caps the afternoon's stakes with the second division of the Perfect Sting. Ohio Sires Stakes champ McSeaside starts as the morning-line favorite with Dexter Dunn taking the drive for trainer Ron Burke. She starts from post 6 in a field of nine which includes Bellisima Hanover (post 3), who gets back on track after scratching from the Shes A Great Lady Final; and

Zanatta (post 9), who gave futile chase to finish second to Twin B Joe Fresh in the Bluegrass.

The Muscle Hill, Six Pack and Chapter Seven International Stallion Stakes are each sponsored by their respective stallion syndicate and by Southwind Farms, Deo Volente Farms and Blue Chip Farms respectively. Melander sends out favorites in Kentucky Futurity, Filly Futurity

Marcus Melander will send out the morning-line favorites in both the \$430,000 Kentucky Futurity for 3-year-old trotters and \$276,000 Kentucky Filly Futurity for 3-year-old female trotters Sunday (Oct. 9) at Lexington's Red Mile.

Periculum, who posted a 1:50.3 win in a division of the Bluegrass Stakes last week, is the 4-1 morning-line favorite ahead of stablemate Temporal Hanover, at 9-2, in the 130th Kentucky Futurity. Joviality S, who has won four consecutive starts since finishing second in the Hambletonian, is the 3-1 choice in the 57th edition of the filly companion event.

Both races have full fields of 12, with spots secured based on seasonal earnings. Two horses in each of the one-mile events will start from the second tier.

Periculum has won only twice this season but has been a steady earner, banking nearly \$275,000 for owners Holly Lane Stud East, Brixton Medical Inc., and Howard Taylor. The son of Muscle Hill—Amour Heiress finished second to Temporal Hanover in the Dr. Harry M. Zweig Memorial and third in the New Jersey Sire Stakes championship, where he started from post 10 at The Meadowlands and was beaten by three-quarters of a length.

In the two most lucrative races of the year so far for Periculum, the Hambletonian and Canadian Trotting Classic, he started from posts nine and 11. He was fifth in the Hambo, beaten only 1-3/4 lengths, and sixth in the CTC, where he was 11 lengths behind after three-quarters of a mile but made up 8-1/2 lengths coming for home.

Last week, Periculum and Brian Sears, driving the colt for the first time, defeated Golden Wall As by 2-1/4 lengths. Rebuff, the favorite, was third. Periculum's time of 1:50.3 is tied for fourth best among 3-year-old male trotters this year.

He will start Sunday from post three with Sears in the sulky.

"He's not a bad horse," Melander said. "He's had some bad luck, some bad posts, but he's raced pretty good this year. Last week, Brian put him on the lead, and he was very sharp. He drew well. It's very exciting."

Temporal Hanover heads to the Futurity off a nose loss to Justice in 1:50.2 in a Bluegrass division. The colt has hit the board in all 10 starts this year, winning four and finishing second on

five occasions. He has banked \$657,000 for owners AMG Stable, Kenneth Kjellgren, Rick Wahlstedt, and Heights Stable.

In addition to winning the Zweig, he captured the Earl Beal Jr. Memorial. He will start Sunday from post five with Mattias Melander at the lines for his brother Marcus.

"He raced super last week too," Marcus Melander said about the son of Walner—Think Twice. "He came off a three-week layoff and it was a fast half in the wind, and he just got beat at the wire. It's hard to say anything bad about him. He always does his best. With the right trip, he's always right there.

"(Temporal Hanover and Periculum) are two very good horses, and both of them have a chance to win."

The Kentucky Futurity is the third jewel in the Trotting Triple Crown. Cool Papa Bell won the second, the Hambletonian, in August. The first jewel, the Yonkers Trot, went to Joviality S in July. She became the first filly since 1996 to win the race.

Joviality S, a homebred daughter of Chapter Seven—Pasithea Face S owned by Courant Inc., has won 10 of 12 starts this year and earned \$922,477. Victories in addition to the Yonkers Trot include the Delmonica Hanover Stakes, New York Sire Stakes championship, and Empire Breeders Classic.


Last week, she won a filly division of the Bluegrass by 3-3/4 lengths over Delilah Hanover in 1:50.4. She starts the Kentucky Filly Futurity from the second tier's post 12 with Sears in the sulky.

"She's just unbelievable," Melander said about Joviality S, who has hit the board in 23 of 24 starts, winning 19. "She performs week in and week out. She got a perfect trip (last week) and came out of the race good. She looks really sharp coming into this week too."

Jiggy Jog S, also a Bluegrass division winner, is the 4-1 second choice in the Kentucky Filly Futurity with Elegantimage champion Raised By Lindy next at 5-1.

The Kentucky Filly Futurity is race 10 on Sunday's 12-race card, which will be capped by the Kentucky Futurity. Racing begins at 1 p.m. (EDT) and the stakes-filled afternoon includes an appearance by Bulldog Hanover, history's fastest Standardbred, in the Allerage Open Pace. That event is race 11.
