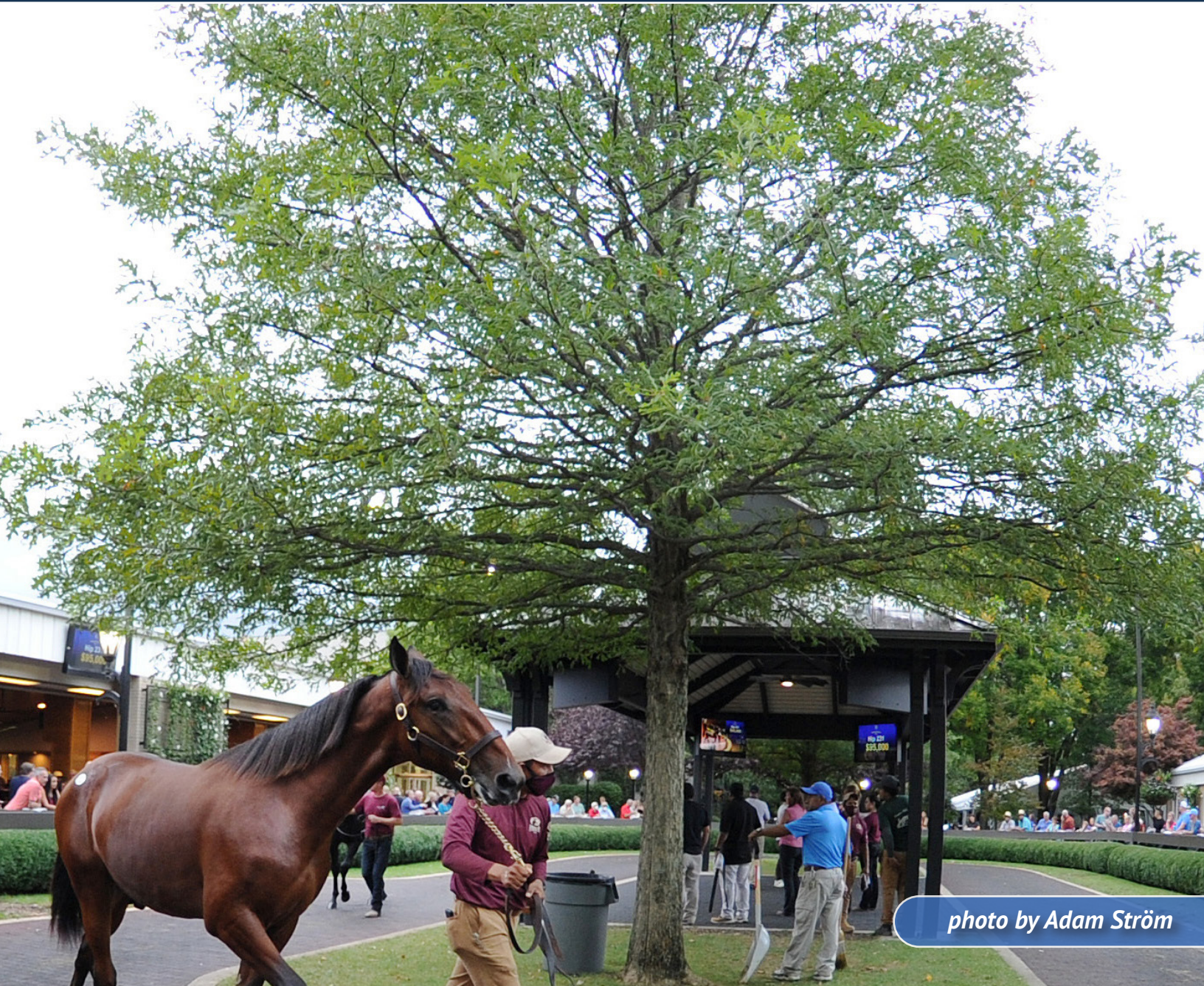

All-time sales record smashed through just three sessions

With two sessions still left to go, the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale has already surpassed the previous record for gross with \$46.6 million in total sales thanks to a record-breaking third session on Thursday night.

The records keep on coming at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale. Just how strong a sale has it been? Through three nights, the auction has already surpassed the previous best for total gross it took five nights to reach in 2019.

At the very end of Thursday's (Oct. 7) session at the Fasig-Tipton sales pavilion, total 2021 sales surpassed the 2019 final sale total of \$46,480,000 that was the previous standard. This year's sale has now reached \$46,609,000 in gross with a little more than 300 horses left to sell.

Thursday's (Oct. 7) auction set a record for gross (\$10,169,000) during a third session that is more than \$2.5 million higher than the previous best for night three. Thursday's auction also

set a new high-water marker for number of yearlings sold for \$100,000+ both for a third session (20) and through the first three sale nights (150).

The third-session **gross was up 57 per cent** from 2020's night three gross of \$6,497,000 and up 33 per cent from the previous third-session record of \$7,656,000 set in 2019.

Thursday saw 222 yearlings go through the ring at the Fasig-Tipton sales pavilion to produce an average of \$45,806. The median was \$35,000. The **average was up 27 per cent** from the 2020 third-session average of \$36,094 and was second best to the third-session record of \$47,594 set in 2017 when 62 fewer horses sold than this year.

Through three days, the sale is up 42 per cent in gross, 23 per cent in average and has recorded 49 more \$100,000+ sellers compared to 2020 when 479 yearlings fetched \$32,905,000 through the first three days for an average of \$68,695. Last year, 101 yearlings reached six figures. The previous records for

gross, average and number of \$100,000 yearlings for the first three days were all set in 2019 when 465 yearlings brought \$38,930,000, total, for an average of \$83,720. That year, 116 yearlings brought \$100,000 or more.

"It goes back to what (sale co-manager) Randy (Manges) said back when we were taking the entries, 'We're putting a catalogue out that's deeper than it had been in the past,'" said fellow sale manager David Reid. "We felt coming in, and it was well publicized, that we had a strong catalogue and here we are through the third night breaking the record from 2019, which was a record from when we sold two horses for a million dollars.

"It goes back to the depth of the catalogue and the diversity of the sires. Just looking at the sire totals here. Walner leads the way at \$7.7 million, then there's Captaintreacherous (\$6.65 million), Muscle Hill (\$5.26 million), Chapter Seven, Father Patrick, Sweet Lou, Tactical Landing, Always B Miki – they've all sold offspring for over \$2 million here.

"Then you come in here tonight and Bettors Delight had a big night. He's at \$1.7 million and you've got American Ideal, Stay Hungry and Huntsville. I mean, we haven't seen a sire list like this in a long time.

"It just shows the strength, but, there again, it's not one reason, it's multiple reasons – the depth of the sire power, the increase in the programs, the foal crop is maintaining flat – I just think there's a lot of positive reasons. I said last week that I think it's a good time to be buying horses. The economy has been rolling along, despite the pandemic. The thoroughbred sales have been pretty good. I just think everything is clicking on all cylinders right now and it all contributes to the success of this sale, there's no doubt about that."

SESSION TOPPER BRINGS \$250,000

Thursday's session-topper was **hip 460 Fout**, a Bettors Delight colt out of Weeper purchased for \$250,000 by Ben Wallace, agent for Daniel Plouffe, from the Winbak Farm consignment.

"He stood out as far as conformation and he comes from the immediate family of speed," Wallace said. "I though with that combination we were on the right track. You never know what you have to pay for them, but I've got an exceptional owner, Danny Plouffe, that's been with me for years on and off, we've won a Triple Crown together (with Blissfull Hall). I guess he remembers that and he wanted that colt, so we went ahead and bought him.

"I think people still want racehorses. That speaks to what winning horse races is all about. The thrill of winning a horse race is sort of shown in how much people want to buy one and be part

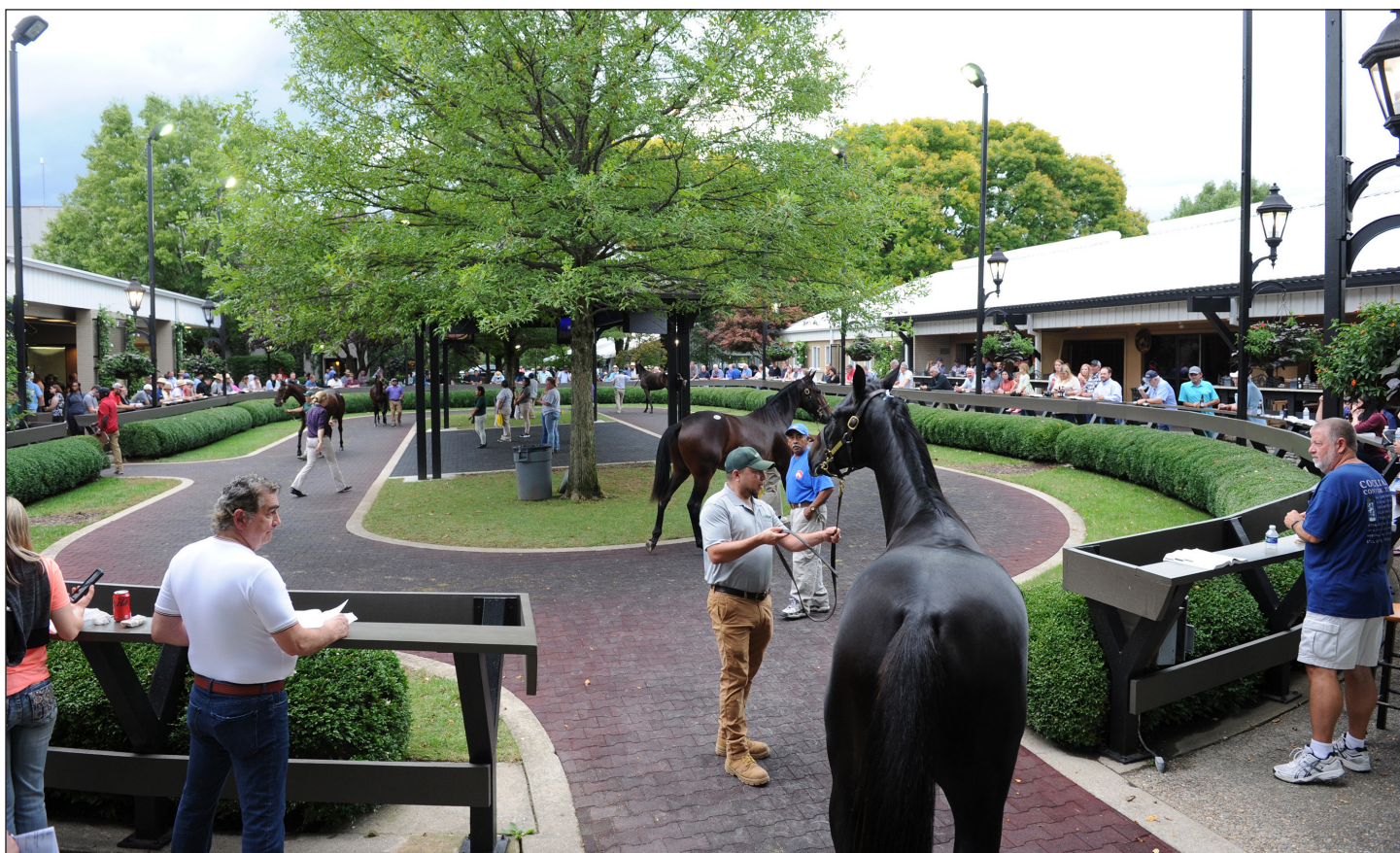

of that mix. I think it's holding up very well. The afternoon sessions seem to work good and it reminds me of the old Tattersalls sessions where we bought and sold horses in the afternoons."

As for going to \$250,000, Wallace said, "we were getting pretty thin. We were prepared, I suppose, if we had to (go higher), but I'm glad we didn't have to. That's trying to protect some people's money I suppose, but that's just the way it is. I have no clue who the underbidder was, but he was aggressive, because from 150 on, I think it was just myself and him. Time will tell, but right now I feel fortunate we were able to get him."

"Anything over 100 grand is a lot of money. I know you were going to have to pay for this one. Ontario offers a great program, and certainly Bettors Delight has shown that he can compete at any stage. So it's nice to have a sire stake colt in your pocket and we're hoping that the Grand Circuit will be an option, too."

OVERHISER THURSDAY'S TOP BUYER

Doug Overhiser of Illinois was particularly active during Thursday's session. He led all session buyers with \$599,000 spent, in all, on seven yearlings. Through three nights, Overhiser has spent \$1,051,000 to take home 14 yearlings. Notable among his Thursday purchases was **hip 364 Morning Edition**, a Walner colt out of Morning Glow that lost one eye as a baby that he

bought for \$145,000.

"He was destined, if you look at him, to be a \$400,000 yearling," said Art Zubrod of Brittany Farms which bred Morning Edition. "He lost an eye shortly after he was born. He still looks the part and he trots the part in the paddock."

Overhiser said he would love to have one of his purchases end up being a Grand Circuit winner.

"Obviously, that's the goal. The one we bought tonight, the Walner colt with one eye, what a story that would be if he hit the Hambletonian? I believe in stuff like that, fairy tales," Overhiser said.

Overhiser also bought the second most expensive yearling sold Thursday when he spent \$210,000 to purchase hip 516 Shes A Lady, a Captaintreacherous filly out of My Lady Love from Brittany.


"The first night is kind of tough, right? You try and find value. (Thursday), there were a couple of horses that we targeted coming into the sale, so that's probably why we've been more active. The first night is when you want to be more careful. The ones we did get the first night, I thought we got really good value. We kind of knew coming in that the third night would be when we'd go hot and heavy on them," Overhiser said.

"I want to have fun and maybe make a little money or, at least, not lose too much money. My family raced harness horses back in the '80s. They got out of it, things didn't go well and I always

"The prices and the horses available will determine that, to be fair, but we've probably come close to the end. Now, my focus will turn to Indiana, going to the Hoosier Classic and we'll see what happens when Harrisburg comes around, once everything shakes out from this sale, for what we may want and need," he said.

"The biggest thing that we took into account this year, and I think a lot of folks have, is the dual eligibility in Kentucky. They have put a lot of money into that program for next year and that's exciting for the business."

PREFERRED LEADING THE WAY

For the second night in a row, David Reid's Preferred Equine led all consignors in gross sales, edging Kentuckiana Farms \$1,794,000 to \$1,657,000. Through three nights, Preferred is the leading consignor with \$7,120,000 in gross for 104 sold. Hunterton is second with \$6,487,000 for 51 sold and Kentuckiana is third with \$5,962,000 for 75 sold.

"Very solid. I haven't looked at all the numbers, but we had a good clearance rate. It just seems like things are rolling along pretty well. We had a mix of pacers and trotters, fillies and colts, and I'm satisfied," Reid said. "There's always bumps in the road, but generally speaking there's been very few bumps. There's some at every sale, but I'm pleased and, for the most part, all of our clients are pleased as well and that's ultimately what makes the difference."

Concord Stud leads all consignors in average (\$186,429), followed by Cane Run Farm (\$157,250), Hanover Shoe Farms (\$155,100), Brittany (\$128,632) and Hunterton (\$127,196).

Anvil and Lace Farm, which led consignors by average during the second session, has a solid average of \$104,154 through three nights.

"That's phenomenal, I'm speechless," said Anvil and Lace's Beth Yontz. "I never thought I'd have that quality of horses that early on. We've been out on our own only since 2015 with the farm, so 2016 was the first consignment. (The sale) is better than

expected. It's been good. We've been good a couple of years and then it comes in now and it's just fireworks."

"No disappointments, whatsoever. Surprises? Just pacing fillies in general, in my own consignment and in others. Normally, pacing fillies brought in the bottom end in years previous. This year, it's been the complete opposite."

Through three nights, pacing fillies are averaging \$84,781 which trails only trotting fillies (\$95,154).

After two straight sessions that started at 3 p.m., tonight (Oct. 8) and Saturday will return to 7 p.m. start times after the afternoon races at the Red Mile.

"The new (afternoon) format was very encouraging," Reid said. "I asked a lot of people and then I talked to the consignors as well, trying to get a broad base of opinion of it and I haven't heard any complaints. We are always conscious of getting people out of here at a reasonable time. Tonight we had a much better pace and got done a little earlier."

The session ended just after 9 p.m.

Historical Averages - Day 3



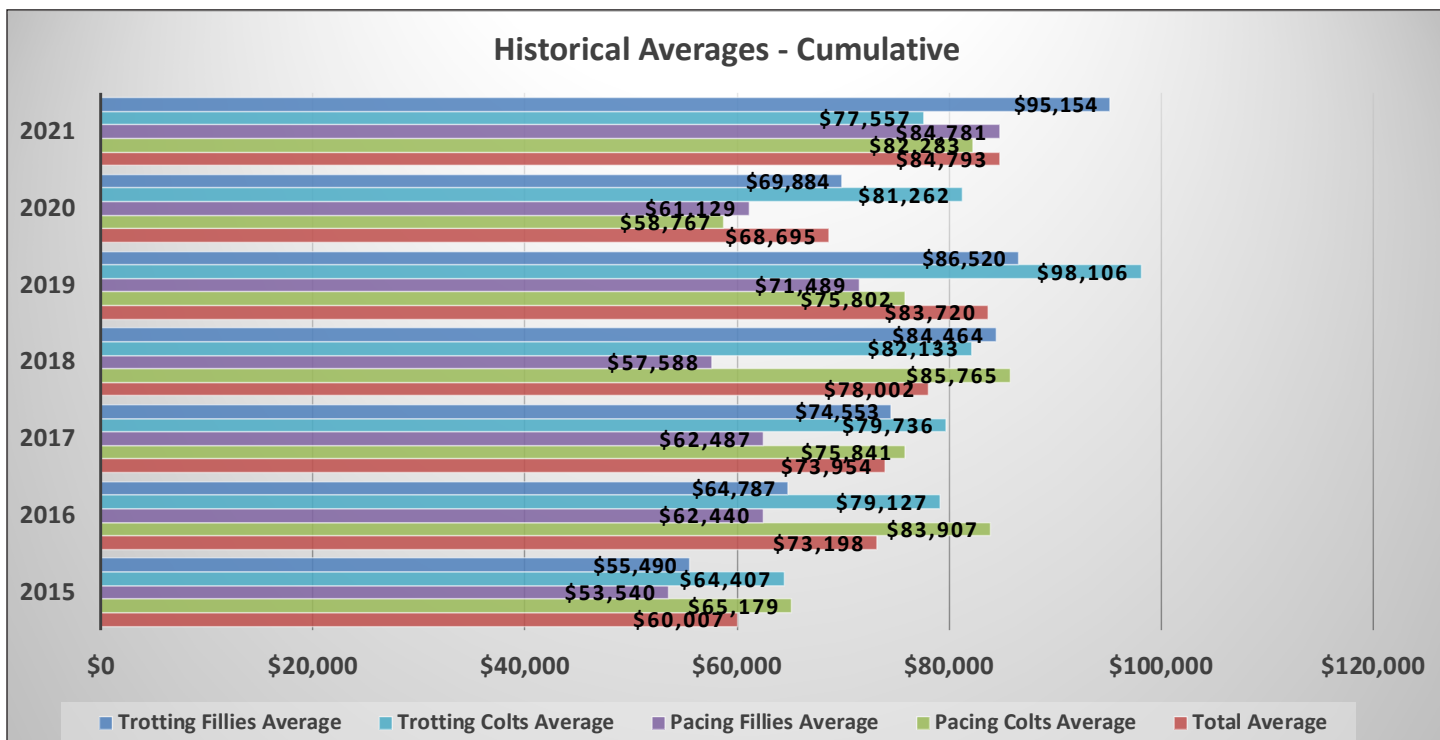

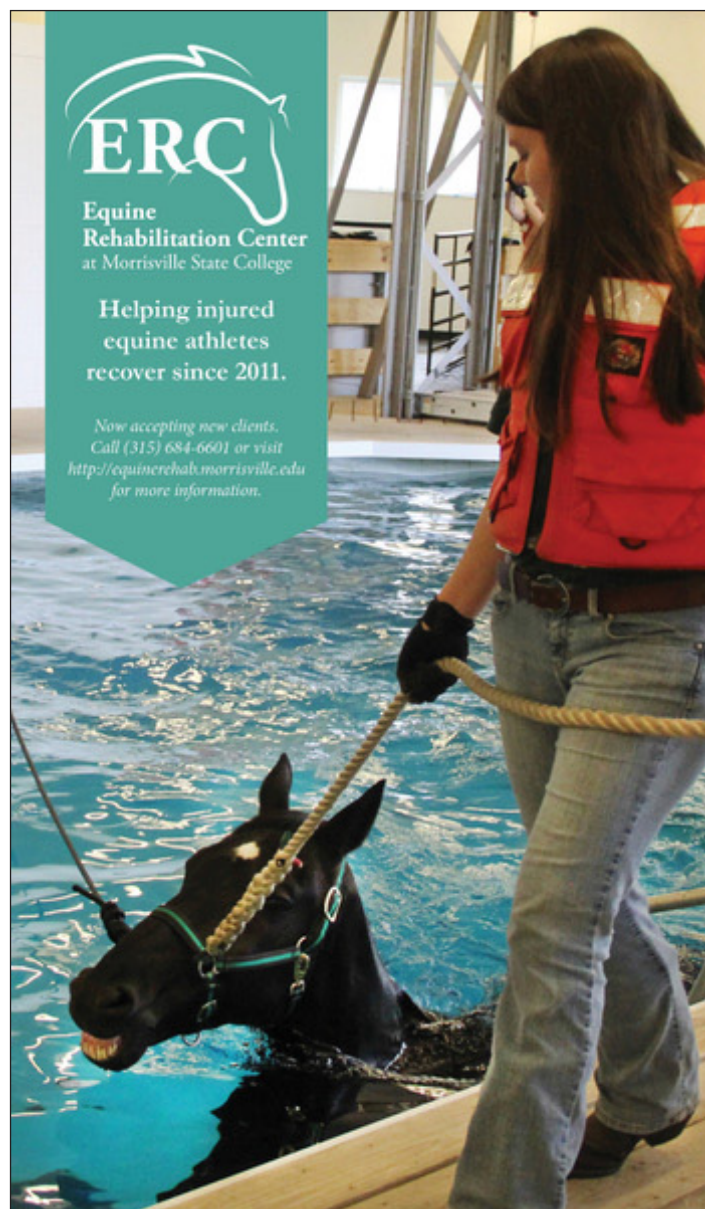

Manchego retired after five racing seasons

She leaves the track as the fastest female trotter in history (1:49) and the fourth richest female trotter in history with earnings of \$3.14 million.

Manchego, a multiple Dan Patch Award winner and world-record-holder, has been retired, owner Barry Guariglia of Black Horse Racing said Thursday (Oct. 7). The 6-year-old trotting mare will head to Kentuckiana Farms for the next phase of her career as a broodmare.

A daughter of Muscle Hill out of Secret Magic, Manchego won 39 of 65 lifetime races and earned \$3.14 million. Her earnings rank fourth in history among female trotters, trailing only Moni Maker, Peace Corps, and Bee A Magician.

She is the fastest female trotter in history, with a mark of 1:49 established in 2019. She also is the fastest female trotter ever on a five-eighths-mile track, with a time of 1:49.3 set in 2020. She is the only trotter in history to win with a sub-1:50 mile in three different years, which she accomplished in 2019, 2020, and 2021.

Manchego was the sport's fastest trotter in 2019 and 2020, and her best win time of 1:49.4 this year is tied for second.

In 2017, Manchego won all 12 of her starts and became the first undefeated 2-year-old filly trotter in Breeders Crown history as well as the first unbeaten 2-year-old filly trotter to win a Dan Patch Award.

Manchego captured a second Dan Patch Award last year, when her accomplishments included joining Peace Corps and Grades Singing as the only female trotters with at least three Breeders Crown trophies.

In addition to winning three Breeders Crown finals, Manchego's career triumphs included the 2018 Hambletonian Oaks, the 2017 Peaceful Way and Jim Doherty Memorial, and the 2020 TVG Series Open Trot championship. She was a two-time winner of the Spirit of Massachusetts, in 2020 and 2021.

Other triumphs this year included the John Cashman Memorial, Arthur J. Cutler Memorial, and Maxie Lee Memorial. Her win in the Cashman made her the first mare to capture the event over the boys since Moni Maker in 2000.

For this season, she won six of seven races before finishing off the board in consecutive starts. She was scratched from the Dayton Trotting Derby last week.

Manchego was the sport's No. 1-ranked horse in the Hambletonian Society/Breeders Crown poll for 13 weeks this year. She is No. 6 in the current poll.

"She had a great career, so many wonderful moments," Guariglia said. "We'll miss her last couple starts, which would have been great, but we just decided it was enough. It is what it is. We can't complain. I knew it would end one day. And here it is."

The Brittany Farms-bred Manchego was trained by Jimmy Takter at ages 2 and 3, and Nancy Takter at 4, 5, and 6. She had two regular drivers during her career, Yannick Gingras and more recently Dexter Dunn.

Nancy Takter said in a 2020 *Hoof Beats* story that Manchego's gait set her apart.

"It's amazing to sit behind her; she's like a little bouncy ball," Takter said. "Her gait is completely unique. She is so efficient the way she goes. It's really like she's on springs. She springs forward and covers so much ground effortlessly."

"Obviously, she's got the mentality to her that makes her a fighter and a winner. She's just amazing. I feel like there really isn't much more I can say about her. How many times can I say she's amazing?"

"There isn't another one like her."

Guariglia on Thursday agreed.

"She truly will be missed," he said. "She will always be the big cheese to us."

Unequal pay

Investigating why Breeders Crown events for pacing and trotting mares go for half as much as the other Crown events.

At the end of September, the Hambletonian Society announced that they would be adding \$600,000 to this year's Breeders Crown purses by adding \$100,000 to the finals for all four sophomore events as well as the Open Pace and Open Trot.

"We have some excess money to put into purses for the Breeders Crown this year," said John Campbell, president and chief executive officer of the Hambletonian Society. "And the process is that it goes before the Breeders Crown committee of the Hambletonian Society and they determine where that money goes and that was their decision. At this time, we're in a position where we're comfortable raising those purses and not having a detrimental effect in the next year or so on them, so it's a year-to-year thing in that regard."

Rather than focusing on the Breeders Crown committee's benevolent act, some took to social media to question why no love was given to the mare pacers and trotters. With the increase this year, all Finals will go for \$600,000 except the mares who will each race for \$300,000.

The owners of some of the top mares would have appreciated a slight bump in their purses as well, but recognized that the

issue is not with the Breeders Crown that offers one of the top mare purses in North America. The problem, instead, is with the industry as a whole that, just like all other professional sports, rarely offers equal pay to females.

"It's always been that way," said owner Howard Taylor. "When [Buck I St Pat] was around, she was racing for half of what the boys were, that's why with Atlanta we go with the boys. I guess you accept that it is what it is but it's such a difference, it's just not fair. If it was a little less, I'd say okay, but a lot of the mare races go for a lot less than the boys."

It was explained that the Breeders Crown Mare Trot traditionally goes for less money in the hope that top trotting mares, such as Atlanta and Manchego, would choose to race in the Open Trot against the guys thus pitting the top trotters, regardless of sex, against each other. Some have tried but only three have won, the last being Hannelore Hanover in 2017. Prior to that it was Moni Maker in 1998 and CR Kay Suzie in 1996.

It's been even worse for mare pacers. The last one to race in the Breeders Crown Open Pace was Put On A Show in 2012, who finished last, beaten 10 $\frac{3}{4}$ lengths.

"She tied up that night and she was no good," said Put On A Show's trainer, Chris Ryder. "She wouldn't have beaten the mares that night."

Taylor has owned both pacing and trotting mares and knows there's a difference when it comes to competing against the guys.

"Lyons Sentinel, arguably, could take on the boys but she'd be the only one," said Taylor. "I have Peakie Sneaky, who's a top-five mare, I think, and I wouldn't even consider that."

Lyons Sentinel, a 4-year-old mare pacer, is trained by Jim King Jr. and owned by Three Lyons Racing, which is comprised of Geoffrey Lyons Mound and his two sons, Joseph and Geoffrey. She currently sits at the top of the Hambletonian Society/Breeders Crown weekly Top 10 Poll.

"In your 4-year-old career, you're racing against 5-, 6-, 7-, 8-year-old mares, so that's difficult enough, and then to go against aged boys is another level again," said Joseph Lyons Mound. "We're lucky, we've got a nice amount on our card this year, but if it was the same caliber of money as a 3-year-old, we'd probably be hitting a million already, so there's a difference."

"This year we paid into maybe eight [stakes], whereas as a 2- and 3-year-old, you could pay into maybe 20. They don't do anything to keep you racing. It's not as if they're trying to keep you in the sport longer. They're really trying to put you to the sidelines breeding from the looks of it."

King Jr. knows quite a bit about racing top mares, such as Horse of the Year Shartin N, but when it comes to pacing mares taking on the boys, he's not currently in favor of it.

"Even if they win it takes a big toll on them," said King Jr. "I've seen it repeatedly and even if they get it done that night the after effects don't make it worth it, in my opinion. If I had [Lyons Sentinel] as a trotter, I'd feel differently about it."



Dave McDuffee, owner of 2021 Hambletonian Oaks champ Bella Bellini, currently plans to breed her next year rather than bring her back at 4.

"Four is a tough, tough year to race any horse, whether it's male or female," said McDuffee. "I feel bad for 4-year-olds. If there were more 4-year-old races with good purses, I know for a fact that good mares that we had that we quit with at 3 we would have kept on for another year."

Part of what could contribute to the Crown mare purses being less is the fact that less than half as many females are Crown eligible at 4 than at 3. They also have fewer and lower payments than their male counterparts.

On a positive note, the fact that the Breeders Crown offers the

exact same purse to 2- and 3-year-old males and females is unique and refreshing and something that others can hopefully use as an example moving forward.

"There was a lot of discussion on what to do with [the money]," said Campbell. "It wasn't a question of not giving it to the mares, it was just a question of where it would go and that's where we fell. As far as keeping mares on the track, 4 and up, it's going to take a series of races throughout the year for that to come to fruition. It's not going to be just for one race."

Key dates in Kentucky Futurity and Tattersalls history

The Kentucky Futurity, which began in 1893, is the oldest of the sport's Triple Crown races. The others started as follows:

1926 Hambletonian

1946 Jug

1955 Cane Pace

1955 Yonkers Trot

1956 Messenger

In 1893, seven colts and four fillies tangled in the inaugural Futurity. There was no Preakness held that year and the Belmont had just five competitors and the Kentucky Derby had just 6.

The Kentucky Futurity was not held from 1942-1945 making this year the 125th edition.

From 1893-1920, you had to win three times to be declared the Futurity winner.

Father Patrick has won the last two editions of the Futurity from his first two crops — Greenshoe and Amigo Volo.

Only three drivers in history have won each of the Trotting Triple Crown races at least three times each: Mike Lachance, John Campbell and Brian Sears.

Lachance has three Yonkers Trots and four each in the Hambletonian and Futurity.

Sears has four Yonkers Trots and three each in the Hambletonian and Futurity.

Campbell has three Yonkers Trots and six each in the Hambletonian and Futurity.

Team Pinske won both the Kentucky Futurity with Amigo Volo and the Filly Futurity with Love A Good Story in 2020. Carter Pinske tried to put it into words, "It as unlike any other day I ever had or ever will have again. Quite honestly, after Story won, I was a little bummed because I told (my wife) MaKenna, 'There's no way we are winning both these races.' It was a very surreal and humbling day. Capped off by the crazy outpouring of support and congrats from so many people afterwards. I'll never forget that day."

This is the final Triple Crown race of 2021. Just who are some of the biggest names never to win a Triple Crown race?

Presidential Ball 1993

Chapter Seven 2011

Father Patrick 2014

Rocknroll Hanover 2005

Real Desire 2001

Gallo Blue Chip 2000

Staying Together 1992

Artsplace 1991

Forrest Skipper 1985

Remembering the 2005 Kentucky Futurity

Strong Yankee won it in a two-horse raceoff that went in 1:51.2 to produce a three-heat world record.

Vivid Photo and Strong Yankee won the elims, Classic Photo was third in both heats and Sir Perseverance at 10-and 150-1 was second on both.

Trond Smedshammer won the 2004 Triple Crown with Windsongs Legacy and the 2005 Yonkers Trot and Futurity with Strong Yankee to capture five of the six Trotting Triple Crown events in consecutive years.

The Gold Dust Twins

That nickname used to refer to Stanley Dancer and Billy Haughton and then to Campbell and Bill O'Donnell. Triple Crown racing is certainly a big part of how they got their nickname. In the decade of the 1970s, 60 Triple Crown events were held – 30 on the pace and 30 on the trot – and 27-of-60 races went to someone named either Dancer or Haughton.

In the 1980s, again 60 Triple Crown events were held and 20-of-60 went to someone named either Campbell or O'Donnell.

The Tattersalls

The race began in 1971 and Horse of the Year Albatross won in 1:54.4 twice for a new world race record.

"Keystone" combinations clicked in three of the first six editions:

1973 Keystone Smartie (Joe O'Brien)

1974 Keystone Presto (Peter Haughton)

1976 Keystone Ore (Stanley Dancer)

This year marks Brett Pelling's 30th anniversary of winning his first Tattersalls in 1991 with Stoneridge Scooter.

Last year saw a colt and filly each win their Tattersalls divisions, just like their sires did:

Party Girl Hill 2020, Captaintreacherous 2013

Tall Dark Stranger 2020, Bettors Delight 2001

There was a dead heat in 1987 with Laag-Jaguar Spur.

The 1983 Tattersalls was the first year the purse reached six figures.

A quarter century went by before the race was held in divisions – 1995 Nicks Fantasy and Stand Forever.

Twelve of 50 times the Jug winner has doubled up in the Tattersalls.

Always B Miki and J K End Of An Era shared the 2014 spotlight on Tattersalls Day.

Seventeen of the 20 drivers to win the Tattersalls from 1971-1990 made the Hall of Fame.

Ten of the 50 winners of the Tattersalls were voted Horse of the Year.

This Saturday is five years to the day of Always B Miki's 1:46 world race record mile.

The winners from 2012-2014 have all distinguished themselves quite well off the track, as well:

2012 Sweet Lou

2013 Captaintreacherous and Sunfire Blue Chip

2014 Always B Miki and J K End Of An Era

The prime time players in the greatest ever Meadowlands Pace – Somebeachsomewhere and Art Official – each won their 2008 Tattersalls divisions.

Full brothers won it – Western Terror in 2004 and If I Can Dream in 2009.

Western Ideal's first crop took center stage in 2005 when both Rocknroll Hanover and American Ideal stole the Tattersalls show.

No Pan Intended won the Tattersalls in 2003 and the Triple Crown and Breeders Crown.

Test Of Faith impressed last week. Her sire, 22-year-old Art Major, won the 2002 Tattersalls.

The richest edition came in 2010 when Rocknroll Heaven won for a purse of \$604,000.

Joe Holloway won the Tattersalls in 1985 with Tylers Mark and again in 2014 with Always B Miki. Thirty-five years after his first Tattersalls win, will Holloway win this year with Perfect Sting?

Niatross, in 1979, raced his last four freshman starts at the Red Mile – and his last six races at age 2 in Kentucky, but he did not race in Kentucky in 1980 at 3, excepting, of course, his time trial.

Farber quick to appreciate 'Cool Papa'

James Thomas Bell, better known by the nickname Cool Papa, is considered one of the fastest players in baseball history, perhaps even the fastest. Bell, an outfielder, was one of the stars of the Negro Leagues, playing from 1922-46, and was elected to the Hall of Fame in 1974.

Stories of Cool Papa Bell's speed are legendary, most notably Satchel Paige's oft-repeated tale that Bell was so fast he could flip off the light switch and be in bed before the room was dark. So, when horse owner and **former college baseball standout Scott Farber** was deciding on a new name for a yearling trotter he purchased last fall, he turned to the national pastime.

The horse he bought under the name Seven Year Itch became Cool Papa Bell.

Cool Papa Bell has finished no worse than second in six races this season, winning three and earning \$124,774 for Farber's Runthetable Stables and trainer Jim Campbell. Today (Oct. 8), he competes in the first of four International Stallion Stakes divisions at Red Mile.

"I'm a big baseball guy, and I take a lot of pride in my knowledge of the game and the history and the players," Farber said. "Cool Papa Bell was known for his speed. I was hoping the horse would live up to the great baseball player's name, and so far, he's done just that."

Farber purchased Cool Papa Bell for \$100,000 at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale. It was the first time Farber, who now primarily races homebreds produced by his six-broodmare band, spent six figures on a yearling.

Cool Papa Bell is a son of Chapter Seven out of Blk Thai Optional. He is a full brother to filly Aela Jamieson, who was second to Iteration in last year's New York Sire Stakes championship for 2-year-old female trotters. His family also includes Breeders Crown champ Martiniontherocks and Peter Haughton Memorial winner Weingartner.

"I wanted a Chapter Seven; I wanted to race in New York, it's a great program," Farber said. "It's a lot of traveling, but it's a great program. I liked his full sister, Aela Jamieson. I followed her very closely.

"So, I went to Jim, like I do at every sale, and told him the horses I like. I don't care if it's one dollar or a hundred-thousand dollars, without Jim's approval on a yearling, I don't do it. We were in agreement (on Cool Papa Bell). I liked the horse from his pedigree. Jim liked the horse from the look and the video and all that good stuff, so we went ahead."

Farber's Runthetable Stables topped \$1 million in earnings for the first time in 2020 and was nominated for Breeder of the Year by the U.S. Harness Writers Association thanks to the success of homebreds Next Level Stuff (Breeders Crown winner), Hobbs (New York Sire Stakes champ), and Take All Comers (Grand Circuit winner). That success enabled Farber to pursue Cool Papa Bell.

"I had a really good year last year, so I was able to extend my normal range of purchase power and we got him," Farber said. "I always like to have one that Jim picks out if I can afford it just to supplement the homebreds. As it turned out with Cool Papa Bell, it's a good thing that I did. My (2-year-old) homebreds were turned out this year for growth and various things that 2-year-olds get turned out for, and this guy has kind of stepped in and saved the day from my 2-year-olds standpoint. I'm very fortunate to have him."

Cool Papa Bell, who won three preliminary rounds of the New York Sire Stakes series and finished second in the final, is the 9-2 morning-line third choice in his International Stallion division. Branded By Lindy, coming off a 1:52 win in a division of the Bluegrass Stakes, is the 9-5 favorite while Peter Haughton and William Wellwood Memorial winner King Of The North is the 2-1 second pick.

"To this day, everything has gone to plan (with Cool Papa Bell), but it's a big step up (today)," Farber said. "We're going to find out a lot about what this horse has and whether he's a Breeders Crown-type horse.

"Jim is a very conservative guy, so he's not making any promises, which you can't make in this business, but he really likes the horse. I like that he tries, I like that he's professional, I like the things Jim tells me. It's very encouraging."

Final round of ISS events in the books at Hoosier

Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino played host to a stakes filled card on Wednesday (Oct. 6) and with it played host to the final preliminary rounds of stakes action. The Hoosier State's top trotters and pacers were on display to solidify their spots in the \$250,000 Indiana Sires Stakes Super Finals slated for Oct. 15 at Harrah's Hoosier Park. Two divisions for the 2-year-old filly trotters, 2-year-old filly pacers and 2-year-old colt trotters were featured on the evening's 14-race card.

M-M's Dream looked every bit the part of a 6-5 favorite as she coasted to a 1:56 victory over Jusmakinyalook and driver Jordan Ross in the opening \$65,000 division for 2-year-old trotting fillies. Driven by Sam Widger, M-M's Dream moved to the lead down the backside and saved a :27.3 closing quarter to hold off all challengers. Trained by Henry Graber, the daughter of Swan For All—Trading Places recorded her fifth win from seven starts this season. M-M's Dream is owned in partnership by Eleven Star Stables, F. Baldachino, and Hillside Stables.

In the second division for 2-year-old trotting fillies, **Fleurie** turned in an impressive effort of her own to score in 1:55.1 as the heavy betting favorite with driver Peter Wrenn in the bike. Switching up her tactics from previous starts, Fleurie opted for a trip off the pace but still went on to win by nearly four lengths. Trained by Melanie Wrenn, the homebred daughter of Muscle Massive—Renees Pocket recorded her fifth win of the season from seven starts and established a new lifetime best with the victory.

The 2-year-old trotting colts followed suit as the heavy favorites prevailed in both divisions. **Dover In Motion** returned to Harrah's Hoosier Park after racing in the Mohawk Million in his last start and posted a 1:54.2 gate to wire score. With Ricky Macomber Jr. in the bike, Dover In Motion went to the front and never looked back — en route to a four and a quarter length victory over Yo Mister and James Yoder. Owned by M&M Racing and Norbert Joseph Maza, the gelded son of Dover Dan—Keystone Sadie recorded his seventh win from 8 starts for trainer Jamie Macomber.

Ponda Adventure and Trace Tetrack captured the second division of stakes action for the 2-year-old trotting colts and geldings in 1:54.4. Ponda Adventure went to the front from post seven and was able to repel a late surge from Head Games and LeWayne Miller to get the victory. Trained by Erv Miller, Ponda Adventure notched his eighth win of the season from nine outs. Owned by Engel Stable, L.A. Willinger, and J.D. Graham, the gelded son of

Swan For All—Wildflower pushed his seasonal earnings over the \$200,000 mark with the victory.

The biggest upsets of the evening were found in the 2-year-old pacing filly divisions on the card as **Lorraine Smoke** and James Yoder pulled the slight upset and pay \$10.20 to win. Utilizing her customary late closing kick, Lorraine Smoke paced home in :26.4 to score in 1:52.4 over a track rated sloppy. Owned by Cheyenne and James Yoder, Lorraine Smoke has now won two of 12 lifetime starts.

In the final division, **Always Gonna B You** scored her second straight Indiana Sires Stakes win for trainer Jeff Cullipher and driver John DeLong. Scoring in a new lifetime best of 1:51.1 over a sloppy rated track, Always Gonna B You found late racing room up the inside to score. Trained by Jeff Cullipher, the daughter of Always A Virgin—Passing Fancy is owned by Val D'Or Farms in partnership with Roll The Dice Stable, who also bred the filly.

Today's \$200,000 PA Fairs finals could be Schadel showcase

Today's (Oct. 8) \$200,000 Pennsylvania Fairs championships at The Meadows bring together the finest 2- and 3-year-old performers from across the Keystone State, yet the event could become a showcase for trainer/driver Todd Schadel.

Schadel will send out 12 horses in the eight races, which he says probably is a record for him. Moreover, his brother and sister-in-law, Tony and Linda Schadel, have four finalists, meaning

that of the 68 horses in the championships, nearly 25 per cent represent the Schadel family.

Today's 14-race card kicks off with a non-wagering event, the championship for 3-year-old colt and gelding pacers. All other races are part of the pari-mutuel program. On the wagering front, the program offers a \$19,427.24 carryover in the final-race Super Hi-5. Special fall/winter post time is 4 p.m.

Schadel has at least one starter in seven of the eight finals, missing only the championship for freshman colt and gelding trotters. He had one who qualified there, Lebron Hanover, but had to scratch him due to sickness.

It isn't that Schadel necessarily targets fair racing as his primary venue. He was, after all, partnered with Roger Hammer in Vivid Photo, who made harness racing history with an improbable win in the 2005 Hambletonian. Yet even Vivid Photo raced at the fairs prior to his unforgettable Hambletonian victory.

"I buy horses to make a living with, and I try to buy them at the right price," says Schadel, a resident of Spring Glen near the Gratz Fairgrounds in central PA. "I can't go out there and spend \$200,000 or \$300,000 to buy horses to compete in sires stakes, yet that's what this business is. I try to buy them where we can make a profit, then go back the next year and buy more."

Indeed, Schadel didn't give more than \$50,000 for any of his finalists, yet they've already banked more than \$650,000 combined.

Asked to handicap his "Dazzling Dozen," Schadel says these three have perhaps the best shots at titles:

- Tonianne, a sophomore pacing filly who's already won 14 times for owners Andy Miller Stable and Louis Willinger.

"She raced awfully well for me last week. They'll have a tough time beating her," Schadel says. Miller will pilot the daughter of Somebeachsomewhere-Table Talk from post 2, race 6. She's one of seven horses Miller will drive for Schadel in the championships.

- Buchannon Hanover, a son of Always B Miki—Beachbunny Hanover. The freshman pacing colt goes from post 7, race 4 for Miller.

"He was running over horses last week. Andy will figure him out. If he has a little bit of luck, he'll be fine.

- Terry A Hanover, a 3-year-old pacing colt named for the late Terry Altmeyer, a stalwart of the PA Fairs circuit.

"He has a great personality, and he's been nothing but a money maker. He's done his job, and he's a nice horse to drive."

Miller will guide the son of Artspeak—Triplet Hanover from post 3 in the early non-wagering event.

Rare gifts powered Sweet Soul David to Saturday's final

Ancaster resident Pat Lang has worked with a long list of superstar horses, but the trainer puts 3-year-old trotting gelding

Sweet Soul David — who makes his bid for the 2021 Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Grassroots Championship this Saturday (Oct. 9) at Woodbine Mohawk Park — in a category of his own.

"He's a very special horse. I always say to people, the characteristics of a human being that you would love, he has them all. He's kind, he's gentle, he's compassionate, he has tremendous integrity because he never changes, and he has courage," said Lang. "He's got all these things that you would want in a human being, and he goes out and he wins, so yeah, he's a special horse."

The son of Kadabra and A Sundae On Sunday was bred by Lang, Matthew Harrison of Port Perry and Denis St. Pierre and Tiffanee Staley of Guelph, ON. When it came time to name the young trotter, St. Pierre asked the partners if they could choose a name that honored his son David, who died in a traffic accident a few months after the colt was born in 2018.

Although St. Pierre would sell his share in the gelding, he stepped into the race bike last summer and drove Sweet Soul David to victories in the elimination and final of the Balanced Image Trot at Hanover Raceway. Lang said the winner's circle celebration was an emotional one as the group embraced each other and the horse that seems to channel all the best qualities of his namesake.

Those wins would be the only ones on Sweet Soul David's 2-year-old resume as he battled the top colts in the Gold Series program through to a ninth-place finish in the Super Final. This season Lang and his co-owners Simon Swindells of Little Britain, Garth Bechtel of Meaford and Paul Kleinpaste of Orangeville, ON decided the Grassroots level was the best place for the gelding, and he proved them right, notching four wins and one second in five regular season starts and an effortless two-length score in last Friday's Semi-Final.

"The great thing about Sweet Soul David is he never gets beat by a horse that's not better than him. Most horses, the odd race they'll go out and get beat by somebody that's just, it just shouldn't happen, but with him that never seems to happen," said Lang. "If he gets beat, it's because the horse that beat him was better than him. That's pretty rare."

Sweet Soul David and regular reinsman Louis-Philippe Roy of Guelph, ON will line up at Post 6 in Saturday's \$60,000 Grassroots Championship. The race is slated as Race 9 on the Woodbine Mohawk Park program and Lang is anticipating a full-scale battle between the top colts.

"Everybody says to me, 'Well Pat, you said he'd trot in 1:53'. And I say, 'Yeah, he will if somebody forces him to, but he certainly won't if you don't force him to,'" said Lang of the easy-going trotter. "We'll see on Saturday, he's in against three really good horses that are, on paper, as good or better than him. It's going to be a really interesting race."

Of the Grassroots finalists, only The Prince, who won the other \$20,000 Grassroots Semi-Final, has clocked a sub-1:54 mile this season. The Chantal Mitchell trainee won his Sept. 20 Grassroots Leg in 1:53.4. Sweet Soul David's personal best is 1:55, logged July 11 over Rideau Carleton Raceway's five-eighths mile oval.

"Everybody thought he was a half-mile track horse, and of course

it seemed that way because he could leave so fast. He's almost unbeatable on a half mile track, yes, but to his credit he won three races on a half, two on a five-eighths and now I think he's got three wins on a seven-eighths," said Lang of the gelding's 18 race career. "So in actual fact he can win on all size tracks, but he does have an advantage on a half because he's so good gaited and so quick."

Whether Sweet Soul David can add another win over Woodbine Mohawk Park's seven-eighths mile oval to his resume or not, the gelding's connections and far-flung supporters are confident that the trotter will have all his best qualities — courage, honesty, integrity — on display Saturday.

Last of International Stallion Stakes go Saturday at Red Mile

The final dashes of the International Stallion Stakes for the 2021 Grand Circuit meet at The Red Mile swarm the Saturday (Oct. 9) program with seven divisions total between the freshmen trotting fillies and freshmen pacing colts and geldings.

Opening the stakes action on the afternoon is the first of four divisions for the \$314,000 International Moni International Stallion Stake 2-Year-Old Filly Trot, sponsored by the International Moni Syndicate and Hanover Shoe Farm. Kentucky Championship winner Selfie Queen returns to the red clay where she scorched the track on numerous occasions including a 1:51.2 mile in a Kentucky Championship prelim. This time around, the Nancy Takter trainee will try to stay flat after breaking stride around the first turn of the Mohawk Million when launching for the lead from post 10. Scott Zeron takes over the reins as Dexter Dunn opts to pilot Richard "Nifty" Norman trainee Lilbitalexis, who won a Bluegrass division in 1:52.4 last week. The field also has another strong Bluegrass performer in Raised By Lindy, who romped going away in 1:52.1 with a :26.4 final quarter. Yannick Gingras drives the Domenico Cecere trainee from post 5.

Undefeated Date Night leads the second division of the International Moni off a sizzling 1:50.4 performance in the Bluegrass. The Julie Miller-trained champ of the Kentucky Commonwealth Series starts from post 6 in rein to Andy Miller as the 8-5 morning-line choice over Misswalner Fashion, who's listed at 2-1. Tim Tetrack drives that Jim Campbell pupil from the pylon post as she looks to make amends for losing stride as the 1-10 favorite in a Bluegrass division.

Marcus Melander's next upcoming trotting prospect Joviality S,

by Chapter Seven out of the stakes-winning mare Pasithea Face S, fronts the third split of the International Moni. She enters on a four-race winning streak capped by a 1:54.1 victory in the \$200,000 Kentuckiana on Sept. 24 at Harrah's Hoosier Park. Brian Sears pilots the even-money morning-line choice from post 2 against a pair of talented fillies aiming to rebound from miscues last week — Delilah Hanover, third to Date Night in that quick mile, from post 3 and Mon Cheval, who made a wild break before the start in her Bluegrass division, from post 5.

The last International Moni group pins a pair of Bluegrass winners in Jiggy Jog S from post 5 and Palermo Hanover from post 8. Jiggy Jog S jetted from a pocket trip to a 1:52.2 win as the odds-on choice with returning driver Yannick Gingras at the reins for trainer Ake Svanstedt. Palermo Hanover pulled an upset in her victory, lighting the board at 39-1 in a 1:55 win in her division, and has Dexter Dunn in the bike for trainer Noel Daley. Brickhouse Babe, runner-up in the \$326,850 Jim Doherty Memorial and in her Bluegrass division to Lilbitalexis, also starts in the last dash from post 3 with Mark MacDonald in the sulky for trainer Ray Schnittker.

Colts and geldings get underway in their stakes action with the first of three divisions for the \$289,900 Tall Dark Stranger International Stallion Stakes, sponsored by the Tall Dark Stranger Syndicate and Hanover Shoe Farm, in the afternoon's third race. Gulf Shores returns to The Red Mile off the first loss of his career in the Bluegrass last week, settling for second as the 1-5 choice to longshot Nautical Hanover after riding a six-race win streak which included the Ohio Sires Stakes championship. Ronnie Wrenn Jr. pilots the Brian Brown trainee from post 4 against a field which includes Early Action, the Joe Holloway trainee who upended Pebble Beach in a 1:49.4 mile in the Bluegrass. Brian Sears has the call behind that one from post 5.

Pebble Beach competes in the second split of the Tall Dark Stranger, landing the outermost post of the octet for trainer Noel Daley and driver Todd McCarthy. The colt rematches with Tony Alagna pupil Caviart Camden, who bested Pebble Beach in a world-record 1:48.3 mile in a preliminary of the Kentucky Championship Series back in August. Yannick Gingras retains the drive on Caviart Camden from post 5 as he makes his first start since failing as the favorite with a wide trip in the \$650,960 Metro Pace final.

The final division of the Tall Dark Stranger attracts Metro Pace winner Monte Miki, who puts his unbeaten record of four races to test. Scott Zeron steers the Mark Evers trainee from post 3 against such competitors as the aforementioned Nautical Hanover as well as the green Loukes Perry, coincidentally landing post 4 as the brother to Lou's Pearlman makes just the third start of his career. Yannick Gingras will try to keep that Ron Burke pupil flat in a contest also including Kentucky Commonwealth champ Six Feet Apart from post 2 and Kentucky Championship runner-up River Ness from post 7.

Saturday's card features 12 races in all, with first-race post time slated for 1 p.m. (EDT).
