Dave Brower dead at 53

The long-time Meadowlands broadcaster was found dead in Lexington just prior to Friday's Red Mile simulcast.

Dave Brower, the long-time lead TV host, morning-line oddsmaker and program analyst at The Meadowlands, passed away unexpectedly Thursday night while away on assignment at Red Mile. He was 53.

Brower, who recently completed a week-long stint doing TV at the Delaware (OH) Fairgrounds for the Little Brown Jug, was preparing for a huge weekend of racing at Lexington but was found unresponsive in his hotel room after no one had heard from him Friday morning (Oct. 7).

"Dave Brower's level of expertise and professionalism was unmatched in the sport of harness racing, and all of us at The Meadowlands were in complete shock when we heard of his passing," said track chief operating officer and general manager Jason Settlemoir. "While we grieve his passing, we also want to send our condolences to his family and many, many industry friends."

In addition to multiple TV credentials, Brower was a published author, penning "Harnessing Winners" in 2009. A native of Passaic, NJ, Brower also did many national TV broadcasts, which included this year's Hambletonian, seen on the CBS Sports Network.

"Sitting next to Dave Brower for the last five years has been the greatest pleasure of my entire career," said Dave Little, Brower's TV partner since 2017. "He and I got to be friends in the mid-1990s when I was in my first go-round in the Big M's TV department. We have spent so much time together over the years and know just about everything there is to know about the other. I cannot imagine going on camera in a few weeks and not having him beside me."

The yearling sale concluded Friday night surpassing the previous record for gross by more than \$8.5 million.

The 2021 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale concluded Friday night (Oct. 7) setting **16** records, including new standards for gross (\$65,289,000), average (\$73,690), median (\$46,500) and number of yearlings sold for \$100,000 or more (196). The gross exceeded the previous record (\$56,692,500 in 2021) by more than \$8.5 million or 15 per cent. The sale also set the following records:

First session gross: \$23,067,000 (up 24 per cent from \$18,540,000 in 2021)

First session average: \$189,074 (up 17 per cent from \$161,217 in 2021)

"Preferred Equine had a record sale. Steve Stewart at Hunterton had a record sale. I think Kentuckiana had a record sale. Hanover had an outstanding sale here. I think that's equally impressive that there's been a lot of breeders who have been rewarded for their efforts and

their investments and their planning and their risk taking and we just hope it translates to a lot of champions on the racetrack and satisfies the purchaser's dreams of winning classic races or major races."

Reid's co-manager, Randy Manges said, "I have a great crew, great consignors and the event seems to be working. Every year we seem to improve and we have a good group of people come to the sale and buy... a wonderful group of consignors, who do a perfect job with their horses.

"I knew it would be a good sale on the front end because the catalogue was so strong and I had seen a lot of the horses and I knew how good they looked... but to hold up and be how strong it was throughout the sale, I'm really gratified by that."

FIFTH SESSION DOWN A BIT FROM 2021

The fifth session saw 138 yearlings gross \$4,854,000 for an average of \$35,174. The median was \$25,000. Seven yearlings sold for \$100,000 or more, the same as last year's final session. The session was down 8 per cent from the 2021 gross of \$5,285,000 and down 1.5 per cent from the session average of \$35,713 also set last year.

"The session, year-over-year, was flat," Reid said. "It was an even average, maybe down or up a little bit. The Downbytheseasides were very well-received. The Uncle Peters sold well. The Swan

Hanover Shoe Farms set a sales record for consignor average of \$194,174 for 23 yearlings sold in the first two days of the sale. Hip 47 Holy Grail Hanover, (above, being inspected by trainer Ake Svanstedt (right)) sold for \$435,000 to Courant Inc. The Greenshoe colt is the first foal out of former Horse of the Year Hannelore Hanover.

For Alls sold well. Racing Hills sold well, so it's actually very satisfying or gratifying to see the strength and the continuity and consistency of those marketplaces.

"But it was a great night to finish off with the regional programs and you have the national trainers participating in the regional programs — Ron Burke is here, Brian Brown is here — and it's just a testament to the programs that have gotten stronger over the years and it's leveled the playing field somewhat because 15-20 years ago it was all about the Meadowlands. And now it's not all about the Meadowlands because there are a lot of jurisdictions that are healthy and it's good to see. It's better for the industry overall and there's a lot of parity and it showed here tonight."

Manges said, "When I originally started (the regional final session), I didn't know it was going to turn into what it's turned into, but the main reason we did that was that the guys from the original program were busy racing and they couldn't come here for a week. So, the thought was to spread out the regional horses so people could concentration on what they do in the horse business. Then, it turned into a good thing."

Topping the session was **Hip 809 Behest**, a Downbytheseaside filly out of Endowment purchased for \$200,000 by Brian Brown out of the Hunterton consignment.

"I had her mother," Brown said. "She didn't have good conformation. They bought her really cheap, but bought her for a broodmare and she did race a little bit and got a record, but she

The weather was beautiful for all five sessions of the yearling sale.

couldn't stay sound, which wasn't a big deal since they were buying her for a broodmare anyway.

"This filly had good conformation, actually great conformation. My partners on her were very excited to take a chance and they actually spent way more than we expected to... way more than we expected. The breeders, Robinson Brothers, I think they are staying in for a fourth, too. They are behind the mare and the foal and they believe in her, too, so they are going to stay in."

Hip 802 Sea Jammer, a Downbytheseaside colt out of Dancin With Jammy sold to David Cohen, agent, for Micki Rae Stables of Subury, MA for \$160,000.

Hip 869 Twenty Five, a Downbytheseaside colt out of Hula Shuffle sold to the Burke Racing Stable for \$150,000.

Downbytheseaside led all sires in the final session with sales of \$1,723,000 for 27 yearlings sold, an average of \$79,370.

Brown, who trained Downbytheseaside, said, "That's my horse. He's been good to me as a racehorse and as a sire. Right now, in Ohio it seems like that's what you've got to have for the Sires Stakes."

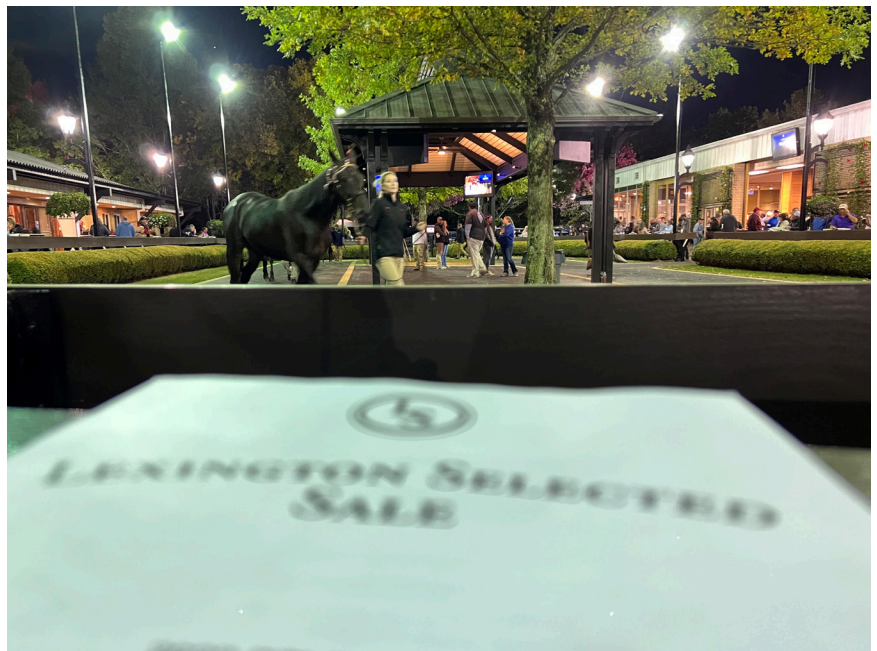
Brown also both a Lather Up filly, Hip 825 Hot Shave, for \$51,000.

"I probably spent a little more on her than we would've liked, too. It's a good family, but a great individual," Brown said.

David Yoder of Hickson Creek Farm sold two yearlings on Friday through Beth Yontz's Anvil And Lace consignment – **Hip 873 Flyin Bullets** for \$150,000 and **Hip 878 Can't Beat Me** for \$65,000.

"I was surprised that they brought that much," Yoder said. "I've never had anything good enough to come to Lexington before.

"My expectations for the first one was from \$50,000 to \$70,000. The last one would be \$50,000, at the highest. They did well."



Yontz said, "The Seaside's always sell great if you have a good one. It seems like they are either really high or really low. He did such a great job, the work was easy for me because I get to promote a good product. But, definitely with Seaside, you've got hope."

Adam Bowden, owner of Diamond Creek that stands Downbytheseaside in Ohio at Sugar Valley Farm said, "I think that's the kind of horse that he can produce. Obviously, not everybody is going to bring sky-high numbers, but you saw opening night when Brent MacGrath sold the sister to Beach Glass for \$400,000-plus... I mean, (Downbytheseaside) has that ability now. He produces Grand Circuit horses. The breeders are getting rewarded. At this time, he stood for \$6,000 stud fee so everybody is making money.

"It's kind of turned into that Day 5 is Downbytheseaside night. We throw a big beach party to start it off, sort of liquor everybody up with free alcohol and food – just music and fun and kind of turn this into a little event. It's worked out good for us, the breeders, the buyers. It's great."

Yontz said she was happy with the sale.

"I thought overall we did very well," she said. "We talked early on and I thought the sale would be up and I think that proved out. Not having anything on the first night, I still held true to that. I think that nothing I had deserved to be on the first night. I think we did better holding them to the second night, bigger fish-smaller pond."

HANOVER SETS SALE RECORD FOR CONSIGNOR AVERAGE

Hanover Shoe Farms led all consignors by a wide margin when it came to average. Hanover averaged \$194,174 for 23 yearlings sold in the first two days of the sale. It was the highest consignor average in the history of the sale.

Hanover sold three of the top 20 horses sold — **Hip 80 Youbet Hanover** for \$550,000, **Hip 47 Holy Grail Hanover** for \$435,000, **Hip 200 Eunoia Hanover** for \$375,000

All American Harnessbreds were second this year with an average of \$127,909 for 11 yearlings. Hunterton was third (\$110,364, 88 yearlings) and Concord Stud (\$108,714 for 14)

PREFERRED LED CONSIGNORS BY GROSS

Preferred Equine led all consignors in gross sales with \$11,261,000 for 145 yearlings.

Hunterton was second with sales of \$9,969,000 for 96.

Hunterton sold the top two horses — sale topper **Hip 57 Epoch** for \$725,000 and **Hip 70 Vic Zelenskyy** for \$550,000 — the fourth highest priced yearling (**Hip 63 Awaiting** for \$525,000) and eight of the top 20 yearlings by price.

Diamond Creek sold over \$2.4 million worth of horses — good for 11th in the ranking — and bought the sale topper Epoch.

Bowden said, "the market is super strong and everybody is riding high. There's no better time to be in the horse business and selling horses. The money is there to race, so people can justify paying these kind of prices, so that's always good for breeders because they are just going to reinvest the money in mares and race fillies."

ALAGNA TOPPED THE BUYERS

Trainer Tony Alagna led all buyers in purchases. He spent \$3,014,000 to take home 21 yearlings.

Douglas Overhiser was the second leading buyer with \$2,223,000 in purchases for 18 yearlings. The Andy Miller Stable was right behind him with 15 horses purchased for a total of \$2,142,000.

Gino Toscani bought the most horses. He signed for 33 yearlings and spent \$1,448,000 to do so.

Hip 1 Above Par Hanover started the sale with a bid of \$62,000 on Monday night. The Greenshoe filly out of Abbie Hall was sold by Hanover Shoe Farms to Marc Goldberg of Woodmere, NY. Greenshoe had a tremendous debut with his first crop, grossing \$6,278,000 for 48 yearlings, an average of \$130,792.

ONLINE BIDDING

As for online bidding, the Proxibid platform sold 37 horses for a total of \$1,167,000.

Zero horses were purchased online on opening night. On Tuesday, four were sold online for a total of \$282,000. Online bidders were the underbidders on eight yearlings on night two. On Wednesday, seven horses were sold online for \$255,000 total. On Thursday, 14 horses sold online for a total of \$400,000. Three underbidders came via online bids. Finally, on Friday, 12 horses were purchased online for a total of \$230,000.

“Obviously, it wasn’t as active as it was in prior years when people could not get here, but it was a tool that was helpful to plenty of buyers,” Reid said. “We’ve had a lot of interest in people getting approved. We know people are using it as a tool. Proxibid is a first-class company to deal with and we’re happy to have them to partner. It’s the best of both worlds because you can have a live sale and have Internet. We all know that online sales have taken off, especially in light of the pandemic, but we didn’t want to stop that because years ago people used to be able to phone bid and I think nowadays people feel comfortable just getting in front of the computer and bidding and it’s worked out well.”

MIXED SALE ON TAP TONIGHT

The Lexington Selected Mixed Sale is tonight at Fasig-Tipton.

“I think it’s going to be good,” Reid said. “Quality always sells. It’s just a matter of how people perceive it. The racehorse market is good and we have some nice racehorses in there. We have some 2-year-olds that have shown some ability early that got off the trail a little bit, but I think they are going to sell well. Then, there are mares that are in foal to good sires, I think there is going to be good demand for that. We’ve got a nice group of weanlings over there. They had interest today and I would expect there will be interest tomorrow. I think the interest is going to be good.”

“Whether you are here or need someone to look at the horses or whatever, they have the capabilities for bidding. I expect to have a solid sale tomorrow.”

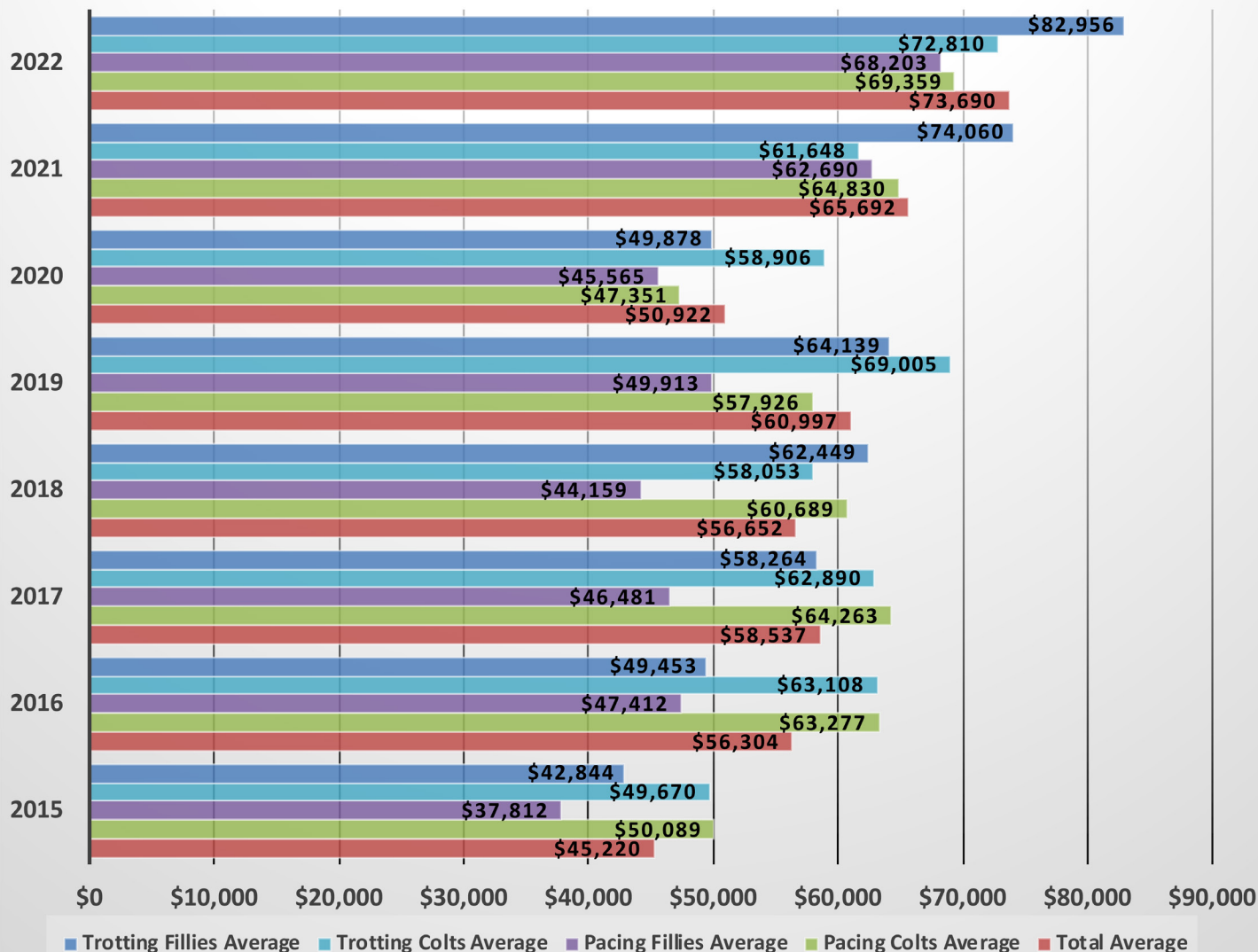

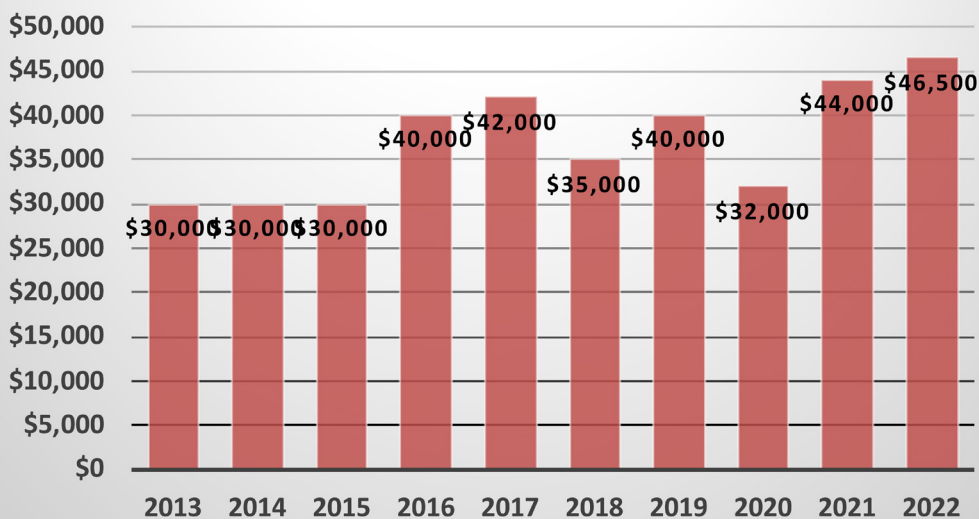
Median - Day 5

Sears aims for Kentucky Futurity sweep, highlights star-studded Red Mile closing day card

Already one of the more anticipated race cards of the year, Kentucky Futurity Day at the Red Mile will get an added boost with a higher degree than normal of subplots throughout the day. Those include getting on the card Bulldog Hanover where another world record is possible, the third to final career race

for Atlanta, another showdown involving Niki Hill who already seems back in top form, a competitive Tattersalls Pace, and more. But the Kentucky Futurity, along with the Kentucky Filly Futurity get top billing, and driver Brian Sears holds the cards in both.

In the Kentucky Futurity for 3-year-old colts, Sears was listed on both Marcus Melander-trained horses, Periculum and Temporal Hanover. In somewhat of a surprise, Sears opted for Periculum, who had been driven almost exclusively this year by Melander's brother, Mattias, and up until last week had posted a record of one win through 11 starts on the season while racing consistently against the sport's best sophomore trotters. But last week, Sears picked up the drive on Periculum and the result was a resounding 1:50.3 win in his division of the Bluegrass. That win was enough to convince Sears to go with him over Temporal Hanover, a horse that has earned \$657,000 to date this season, including a win with Sears three races back in the \$300,000 Earl Beal at Pocono.

On the decision, Sears said, "I felt like Periculum just seems fresher right now, and that there might be some more of an upside to him. Temporal Hanover also raced good last week, and I was happy with his effort too, but the other horse (Periculum), he came home so good and just seemed like he's the fresher horse right now."

Elsewhere in the Futurity from the inside out, how good was Slay in the Canadian Trotting Classic? It's hard to say how much

ground he lost while on that break coming into the stretch, but he was definitely worse off for it, and the fact that he was able to somehow re-gather his momentum to come back on for the win was something else. Branded By Lindy won the KY Championship Series finale the last time he raced here; looked like he was getting towed into it in the CTC when he broke. Rebuff hasn't been bad since arriving in Kentucky but hasn't come back to that summer Meadowlands form either. Pretender gave it a good try last out on the front end and will start from a similar outside post. Hambletonian longshot winner Cool Papa Bell will almost have to come from off the pace, can he surprise again? Justice starts from the second tier and looks to build from his Bluegrass win.

In the Kentucky Filly Futurity, the road goes through Joviality as has been the case all year. Unbeaten on the year in races restricted to fillies, she comes off a three-length score in a division of the Bluegrass at the Red Mile last week. What could complicate things this time is starting from post-12, a second-tier post in a full field.

"There could always be issues in a race like that, with 12 horses," said Joviality driver Sears. "Not being on the gate can be a disadvantage and with horses coming from the outside, but you just have to avoid trouble situations as much as possible and try to get some type of smooth journey. The 12-hole gives us a chance to not have the cleanest trip but I wouldn't trade this spot."

Rival Jiggy Jog S was also an open length winner last week in a division of the Bluegrass, and she'll be one of those fillies that could get an early jump despite starting from the outside as Sears referenced. Peyton Hanover comes off a lifetime best mile last out in the Bluegrass but loses Tetrack as expected to Misswalner Fashion who has turned it back around since her upset win in the Continental victory on Hambletonian Day. Raised By Lindy cruised last out in the Elegance.

To date on the year, Sears has only 350 starts but has earned over \$4 million, and it's not by coincidence that he has both favorites in the Futurity races. Asked how he stays as competitive as he does while driving minimally at times throughout the year compared to other drivers, Sears said, "I do come up twice a year during the winter and train some babies with the Melanders, and that helps familiarize me with the horses that will be racing the year. And I've been fortunate to hook up with a trainer like Marcus who has such a strong barn and appreciate what each of us brings to the table."

Carded as race 11, all eyes will be on Bulldog Hanover in the Allera Farms \$153,000 open pace. The race will take place exactly six years to the day when Always B Miki established a then-world record of 1:46 on Oct. 9, 2016, before it was broken earlier this year by Bulldog Hanover. The weather

forecast looks to be for comfortable temperatures in the mid 60's with sunny skies, we'll see if the pace of the race sets up for another sub-1:46 type of mile. The way he sprinted into another gear through the stretch last weekend at Dayton after never seeing the rail from post 8 continues to add to his legacy.

In the \$205,000 Glen Garnsey Memorial for 3-year-old fillies, a great deal of credit must be given to trainer Chris Ryder on the work in getting Niki Hill back to form in last week's Bluegrass. Making just her second start back following an injury sustained in May, she was powerful all the way in establishing a new lifetime mark of 1:49. Boudoir Hanover who had entered last week with a four-race win streak – and who had defeated Niki Hill in her first start earlier this year – had the entire length of the stretch to go by following a pocket trip but couldn't do so. Those fillies will be joined by Ohio Sire Stakes champion and Jugette runner-up, Sea Silk.

I Did It Myway goes for six in a row in the \$363,500 Tattersalls Pace, and has paced miles in the 1:48 range in every one of those wins. He was fought gamely to the wire last week by Mad Max Hanover after having that one's cover. Fourever Boy was a belated third in that race and continues to be racing in new form for Dunn. In the other Bluegrass division last week it was All About The Hunt who pulled off the upset, but now goes from the inside post all the way to the outside. Pebble Beach was inching in on that rival and did all he could while closing in :25.3. Birthday was rolling up late in that race and it looked like Energetic Hanover was looking for a place to go at times in the stretch; maybe a surprise candidate.

Atlanta and When Dovescry throw down for what seems like the hundredth time in their career. After Atlanta proving too good for When Dovescry on Jug Day, the tables were reversed last week at Dayton where it was When Dovescry who came up the inside to win. Next Level Stuff is always in the mix with those two as well. For Atlanta, it's this race, the Breeders Crown and then the TVG to close out her career.

Test Of Faith faces a compact field of just four other mares in her Allera Farms race. She'll loom a heavy favorite once again; won over this track last year as a 3-year-old in 1:48.3. In the Allera Farms open trot, Cuatro De Julio looks to rebound from a fourth-place finish in the Caesars. Jujubee was third last out at Dayton but that was definitely an improved race in his third start back on the comeback. Scott Zeron drives Ambassador Hanover. Welcome back!

Cool Papa Bell aims for a second Triple Crown jewel in Kentucky Futurity

There will not be a Trotting Triple Crown winner this year, but Hambletonian Stakes champ Cool Papa Bell will try to join the list of horses to capture two jewels when he competes in Sunday's (Oct. 9) \$430,000 Kentucky Futurity for 3-year-olds at Lexington's Red Mile.

Nine trotters have won the Triple Crown, with an additional 20 winning two legs. The most recent horse to get two jewels of

the Crown was Six Pack, who won the Yonkers Trot and Kentucky Futurity in 2018.

Cool Papa Bell, who enters the Kentucky Futurity off back-to-back wins in the New York Sire Stakes final and Phil Langley Memorial, will start Sunday from post nine with Todd McCarthy driving for trainer Jim Campbell. He is 12-1 on the morning line.

The Futurity will have a full field of 12, with spots secured by seasonal earnings. Two horses, Justice and Keg Stand, will start from the second tier.

"He didn't get much favor with the post position, but that's out of our control," Campbell said. "It's (a disadvantage) when there are two trailers, but he's pretty versatile in the way you can race him, so he has that going in his favor.

"It all depends how the race shapes up. If they happen to go real hard in the beginning and he's laying back behind some cover, then I think that gives him his best shot. It's a pretty wide-open race."

Cool Papa Bell, a son of Chapter Seven-Blk Thai Optional owned by Runthetable Stables, has won six of 11 races this year and earned \$796,225.

"He came out of the (Langley) really good," Campbell said. "He's had a good week, he feels good. So far, everything is good."

Marcus Melander-trained stablemates Periculum and Temporal Hanover **are the top choices in the Futurity**, at 4-1 and 9-2, respectively. Seven of the 11 horses in the field are at morning-line odds of 10-1 or less, including Canadian Trotting Classic winner Slay.

Slay, trained by Tony Alagna, has won five of 12 races this season and earned \$514,447 for owners Crawford Farms Racing and James Crawford IV. He has four wins and a third in his past six starts, with a triumph in a division of the Stanley Dancer Memorial joining the Canadian Trotting Classic during that span.

"He's been sharp for a couple months now, racing really well," said driver Joe Bongiorno, who will sit behind Slay for a sixth consecutive start in the Futurity. "This horse has won some major stakes; he might be a little underrated. I think he's a very good colt and I don't think we've even seen his best."

Slay briefly went off stride at the top of the stretch in the Canadian Trotting Classic but recovered to win by a length over Pretender.

"I don't think the footing was quite the same, and he just caught

a boot," Bongiorno said. "He spotted them a few lengths in the stretch and still beat those horses. Obviously, I'm not going to disregard any of those horses (in the Futurity). They're all a bunch of top horses. A couple of them look like they're stepping up right now. Both of Melander's horses are very good horses. It's a very competitive field."

Slay, a son of Chapter Seven-Swinging Royalty, will start the Futurity from post two. He is 10-1 on the morning line.

"I'm fine with our post, it's just about giving the little guy a trip and hoping it's his day," Bongiorno said. "He's probably not a front-end horse. That might have a little bit to do with his size, but as long as you save a little bit for him, he'll give you a big run in the stretch. He tries hard for you."

Each of the past four Kentucky Futurity winners, and six of the past seven, have gone on to receive the Dan Patch Award for best 3-year-old male trotter.

The Kentucky Futurity is race 12 on Sunday's 12-race card, which begins at 1 p.m. (EDT). The race will be preceded by the \$276,000 Kentucky Filly Futurity (race 10) and \$153,000 Allerage Open Pace featuring harness racing's fastest-ever performer, Bulldog Hanover.

Twin B Joe Fresh much the best in International Stallion Stakes

Chris Ryder pupil **Twin B Joe Fresh** began a Dexter Dunn sweep of the \$253,000 Perfect Sting International Stallion Stakes, for freshman pacing fillies, on Friday afternoon (Oct. 7) at The Red Mile.

Dunn stalked from fourth with Twin B Joe Fresh through a :27.3 first quarter but made the move to race first up into a :56.1 half. As pacesetter Treacherous Penny accelerated around the far turn to three-quarters in 1:23.4, Twin B Joe Fresh nonetheless ranged nearer to the lead and easily put away her competition in the stretch to win in hand in a 1:50 mile. Strong Poison rallied from second over for second, beaten 1-1/4 lengths, with Light And Tight finishing third and Caviart Davia taking fourth.

"She's a pretty special filly," Dunn said after the race. "Chris [Ryder] and Pete [Trebotica] liked her from day one and she hasn't let us down yet."

Trainer Ryder also said for Twin B Joe Fresh "Schedule's all over, all over – no more racing this year. [She's] just going to Brittany Farm to be turned out and she has no more stakes left."

Twin B Joe Fresh nabbed her eighth win from 10 starts and added to her account now worth \$598,162. The daughter of Roll With Joe races for owners Chris Ryder, Dexter Dunn, Peter Trebotica and Barry Spak and paid \$2.22 to win.

A few races later, Dunn steered a caught drive in **Mcseaside** – for trainer Ron Burke – to a 1:51.2 victory.

Bellissima Hanover circled Zanatta to the quarter in :28 to lead while Mcseaside was reined in to race third. Coasting through a :56 half, Bellissima Hanover soon faced a challenge from Mcseaside to the far turn while Zanatta raced on a tight hold in a locked pocket. Mcseaside cleared to lead and began separating from the field by three-quarters in 1:24 to turn for home with an open-length lead. The seas parted for Zanatta and she gave futile pursuit to narrow on the winner's margin, but to still finish second beaten a length. Caviart Marcella finished third and To All A Goodnight took fourth.

"[She's] obviously a nice filly," Dunn said after the race. "I'm lucky I picked up the drive on her – not really [a] big [filly], but game. She was a little aggressive, [so] I thought if I started her up too

early in the mile, she was probably going to be a little tired. We came out sort of at the half and [I] tried to get her relaxed a little bit. We moved on from there – she got a little lonely on the straight but held on good.”

Mcseaside, a daughter of Downbytheseaside, won her third race from eight starts and pushed her bankroll to \$283,364 for owners Burke Racing Stable, Beastly LLC, J&T Silva Stables and Knox Services LLC. She paid \$3.16 to win.

Each division of the Perfect Sting International Stallion Stakes was sponsored by the Perfect Sting Syndicate and Brittany Farms / Val D’or Farms.

VOLUME EIGHT STRIKES AT HIGH PRICE IN INTERNATIONAL STALLION STAKES

The shoes came off **Volume Eight** and he threw down the gauntlets to pull a 38-1 upset in the second of three \$290,400 International Stallion Stake (ISS) divisions for freshman trotting colts and geldings on Friday afternoon (Oct. 7) at The Red Mile.

Driver Andy McCarthy motored Volume Eight from post 7 to the top and soon settled for the pocket when Gates Hanover circled to lead approaching a :29 first quarter. The Noel Daley-trained son of Chapter Seven drafted through a :57.1 half and stayed put as Winner’s Bet stalled first over on the rim around the final turn. Past three-quarters in 1:25.1, Gates Hanover came under pressure as McCarthy eased Volume Eight from the pegs and vaulted clear to a 2-1/2-length win over a levelled-out Winner’s Bet with French Wine rallying for third and Upstaged grabbing fourth.

“[He’s] still a little green, but I knew he had a lot of speed,” Andy McCarthy said after the race. “And then sir Noel said today ‘Maybe just leave with him and see what happens.’ I’m like, ‘Oh I’ll check it out,’ but then I went out and I’d seen he was barefoot; I went, ‘Yep, let’s do it.’”

Co-owner John Fodera also said “I was just hoping to get a check. I know Noel and Andy really like the horse a lot – always raising them comfortably and teaching

them – but I think he learned a lot today just leaving out of there and having that gate speed and finishing even better. So it was a shock to me.”

Returning \$79.94 to win, the victory counts as the third from five starts in Volume Eight’s career, which now places his bankroll at \$79,815 for owners Noel Daley, Joe Sbrocco, LA Express&JAF Racing and Mario Mazza. He won the ISS split named “The Six Pack”, presented by the Six Pack Syndicate and Deo Volente Farms.

With 9-5 favorite Kilmister breaking stride at the start, **Excalibur Bi** capitalized to score a 1:53 victory in the first ISS division.



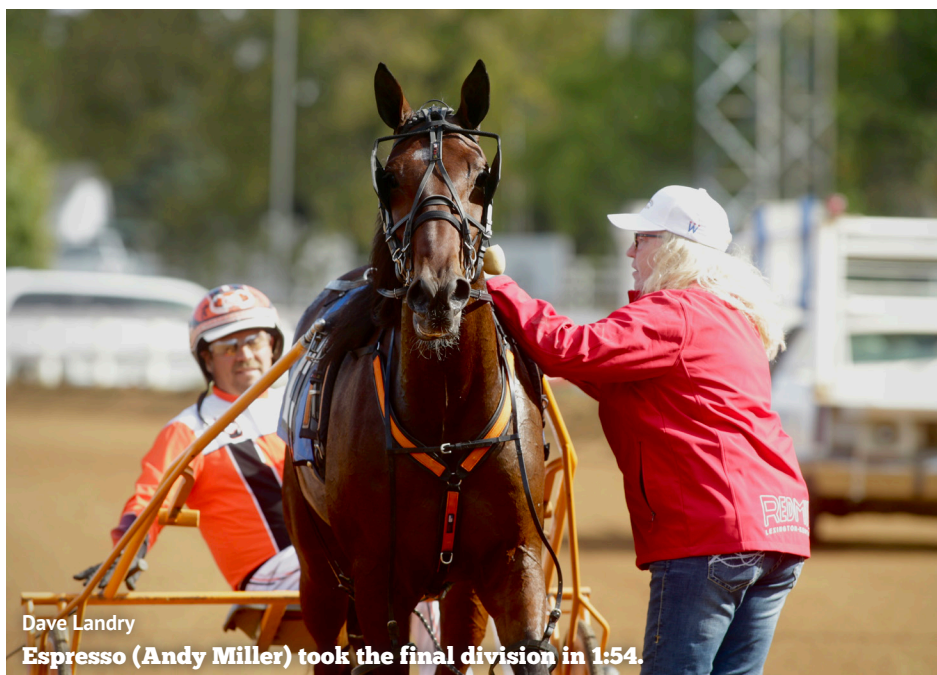
over-drove him a couple of starts back and figured out we need to reset. But it was good the way it worked out today, I got to use him [and] save him until the back half.”

Excalibur Bi competes for owner John Cancelliere. He won his second race from eight starts and has now banked \$126,530. He paid \$5.68 to win in the ISS division named “The Muscle Hill”, presented by the Muscle Hill Syndicate and Southwind Farms.

Espresso landed back-to-back Grand Circuit victories when slipping up the cones to take the third ISS division in 1:54.

Crown, the 4-5 favorite, charged to the top while Espresso obliged to race in the slipstream through a :28.3 first quarter. Little pressure mounted on Crown up the backside with Prince Of Honor steadily angling off the pegs but only minorly advancing after a :57.4 half and to three-quarters in 1:26.2. Turning for home, Crown began drifting from the pylons, which created a wide-enough gap for Espresso to spurt through and grab the lead in the final sixteenth. Crown settled for second, beaten a head, with Kierkegaard K taking third and Herodotus finishing fourth.

“We love coming down here and racing at The Red Mile with a dual eligible horse,” winning trainer Julie Miller said after the race. “We decided to bring him here instead of the New York circuit, and he’s just really matured and just loving the track here.”



Also in rein to Andy McCarthy, Excalibur Bi swept to the top from third after a :27.4 first quarter to pocket early leader Purple Lord. The Thomas Cancelliere-trained son of Muscle Hill cruised up the backside to a :57.4 half and quickened proceedings to three-quarters in 1:26.2 before straightening for the sprint home and uncorking a :26.3 final quarter to win by a length. Purple Lord settled for second with Point Of Perfect third and Cecil Hanover finishing fourth.

“Yeah, he was good, he’s been coming along great,” Andrew McCarthy said after the race. “Tom [Cancelliere] has done a great job with him. It’s has always been a ‘no pressure’ deal with it, just bring him along the way. He thinks right, and I probably

Freshman fights conclude today in Lexington

The Red Mile will host the last of its stakes contests this meet for freshmen this afternoon (Oct. 8) with trotting fillies competing in three divisions the \$317,700 International Stallion Stakes and pacing colts and geldings going in three divisions of the \$299,100 Tall Dark Stranger International Stallion Stakes.

First for the freshman trotting fillies is the \$105,900 Long Tom International Stallion Stake, carded as Race 2. A pair of Bluegrass winners return to Lexington in this split with Mambacita drawing post 8 off a 1:53.2 victory and Railee Something scoring post 4 following a 16-1 upset. David Miller opts to steer Mambacita for trainer Tony Alagna while Railee Something acquires the duties of Todd McCarthy.

Division two, going as Race 6 and named The International Moni, sees Walner Payton escape the grips of standout filly Special Way. Dexter Dunn will drive the Chris Ryder trainee from post 7 as she tries for her first win since taking the New Jersey Sires Stakes final on July 22. This field also includes the third- and fourth-place finishers against Special Way, Secret Volo (starting from post 2) and Royal Filly (post 4) respectively, as well as a developing filly for trainer Bob Stewart in Fruit Cake (post 1).

Trotting fillies finish their engagements in Race 8, named The Walner. Kentuckiana winner Heart On Fire will attempt to make amends off a levelled finish in the Bluegrass last week with Dexter Dunn staying in the bike behind the Tony Alagna pupil from post 1. She starts just two slots inside of Kayleigh S, a Marcus Melander pupil and full sister to Joviality S. Brian Sears sits behind her in the bike.

The Tall Dark Stranger International Stallion Stakes begin in Race 3 with Chris Ryder's speed freak Handlelikeaporsche returning off a 1:50.2 blowout in the Bluegrass. Dexter Dunn drives the colt from post 5 in the nine-horse contest that includes Metro Pace finalist Ants Marching (post 6).

Another Metro Pace finalist, second-place finisher Save America, ships south to start in the second division of the Tall Dark Stranger. Yannick Gingras drives the Nancy Takter trainee from post 4 and opts off his Ron Burke-trained charge Ervin Hanover, who now attains David Miller from post 8.

Bluegrass division winner Admiral Hill competes in the final division of the Tall Dark Stranger. Dexter Dunn drives the Chris Ryder trainee fresh from a 1:50.4 win over the red clay against a field which includes developing Joe Holloway prospect Ammo (post 1), Kentucky Commonwealth runner-up Combustion (post 3) and second-place Bluegrass finisher Gung Ho (post 5).

Each division of the International Stallion Stake for freshman trotting fillies is sponsored by its respective stallion syndicate, with the Long Tom also presented by Midland Acres and the International Moni by Hanover Shoe Farm. The Tall Dark Stranger International Stallion Stakes are presented by the Tall Dark Stranger Syndicate and Hanover Shoe Farm.

First-race post time is 1 p.m. (EDT).

Queen's Reign delivering thrilling season for Watermark Farm

On the racetrack, Queen's Gold collected one win in 16 attempts over two seasons. As a broodmare, she has produced a succession of winners for breeder Watermark Farm LLC. Her latest is the JK Endofanera freshman Queen's Reign, a recent Indiana Sires Stakes winner Wednesday (Oct. 5) at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino. Owned by Watermark and trained by Ernie Gaskin, the filly picked up her third seasonal win in a lifetime best 1:52.1.

"This one came along and we just fell in love with her. She's just been a real surprise for all of us. We're thrilled with her," said Cleo Lowe, who, with her husband, Brad, make up Watermark Farm.

Queen's Reign is the eighth foal from the Riverboat King mare, campaigned by Watermark Farm and Benny Eggers as a two and three year old. Since transitioning to a broodmare, Queen's Reign has yet to miss. Each baby of racing age has gone on to reach the winner's circle, with four six-figure earners and two

in under 1:52. Indy Ingot, a 14-time winner with \$172,402 on his card, leads the first seven, all colts.

"She raced good as a 2-year-old. As a 3-year-old, something was off and we were really never able to put our finger on it. I always liked the mare," Lowe said. "I kept her and bred her. She's had some nice youngsters, but you know how the horse business is. They get sick, something goes wrong, they're not good enough. We've just been playing the game all these years."

Lowe and her husband have a background in saddlebreds and opened Watermark Farm in Lexington in the late '90s. Through that experience they learned of standardbreds.

"My husband is not a rider, so we got him interested in driving, and he became interested in road horses. He's kind of an all or nothing guy, and it was right up his alley," explained Lowe. "I didn't know anything about Standardbreds, and I heard about the yearling sales they used to have at Tattersalls. I thought we could raise and train one."

Lowe attended the 2001 Tattersalls sale and the couple purchased their first standardbred, a Conway Hall colt named One Act Play. They paid \$6,500 for the yearling.

"We went over, and that year was the first year for Conway Hall's first offspring. I was sitting behind the auctioneer, and I said, 'Boy I really like this horse, I wish he would do something so that I can see him better.' He had his back end to me. He raised up, turned around and looked at me. I was like, 'That's it, I raised my hand and bought him,'" she recalled.

One Act Play won two of 28 career starts, but the Lowes were hooked. They fell in love with the excitement of racing.

"He raced in one of the sire races and finished second. We thought this was easy money. From then on, we were punished," Lowe said with a laugh. "We just fell in love with them."

Now in retirement, the Lowes have sold Watermark Farm and have scaled back in their participation. They kept Queen's Gold, however, and have enjoyed her offspring. Now at Cane Run Farm, the mare produced a string of colts before foaling her first filly, Queen's Reign. She delivered three consecutive fillies before being retired as a broodmare. The Lowes have a Stay Hungry yearling and Always A Virgin weanling remaining.

"I wasn't counting on a girl. She was the first one, I now have three," said Lowe.

Gaskin has been entrusted with training the Watermark racing interests for nearly a decade. Queen's Reign is one of the most successful from the mare, but earlier this year, Gaskin wasn't sure just what she would become this season.

"This filly's a little special. She's a JK, she's a beautiful filly. Gosh, she's gorgeous. She doesn't wear anything," commented Gaskin. "She would have been last in her class all winter, just going along, not doing it. You kind of had to tap her to make her do it. Good gaited, but you just had to wonder if she was going to want to do it or not. To prove that, in her first baby race, she went in 2:08. It's been kind of funny to watch her develop into something that good when she showed no indications of it."

Since making her debut this summer, Queen's Reign has missed the board only once in 11 starts. Her lone miscue came in the second leg of Indiana Sires Stakes, where she raced seventh. The filly has registered six runner-up performances, with her three wins coming in her last four attempts, all with Mike Oosting in the bike and each in Indiana Sires Stakes action. The young pacer has banked \$154,250 this season.

"This little filly has really proven herself. We just have our fingers crossed. We're happy, no matter what she does. She's just been great. She's so much fun to watch race," said Lowe, who now lives in Florida and watches her filly race via an iPad.

Queen's Reign ranks fourth in ISS points, qualifying for next Friday's \$250,000 Super Final at Hoosier Park. Her latest victory, coming in a \$68,000 division, established a new lifetime best. Rollin Rosie, another JK Endofanera filly that leads the division in points and is undefeated in her career won the other \$68,000 split.

"I know Rosie's going to be tough competition. I love it that two of the top fillies are out of JK Endofanera. That's going to be kind of fun," said Lowe. "I feel anything could happen. She's definitely up for it, I believe."
