Over \$50 million and counting in Lexington

Thanks to another record-breaking session on Friday night, the Lexington auction is pushing farther into unchartered territory going into tonight's final session.



During Friday night's (Oct. 9) fourth session, the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale **broke \$50** million in gross sales for the first time in its history as the night saw 165 yearlings sell for \$4,771,000, total, to produce an average of \$28,915. The median was \$25,000.

"We averaged nearly \$30,000 tonight, so that's very healthy," said sale co-manager David Reid.

As for breaking \$50 million, Reid said, "I've been wrong the last 10 years. I'm always on the conservative side and I think experiencing it is gratifying for everybody.

"Each time you go on the road in the spring time and you talk to your breeders and you talk to your consignors and start the whole process, then, you see the building blocks and to have them come to fruition and sell like this, and be received like it is, that's very gratifying for Randy and myself."



Friday set records for gross and average for a fourth session, making it the fourth straight record-breaking session this year.

The sale average on Friday was up 32 per cent from the average of \$21,917 from the same session last year and up 6 per cent

from the fourth-session average of \$27,268 in 2019.

Friday's gross is up 29 per cent from the fourth-session gross of \$3,704,000 in 2020 and up 4 per cent from the session gross of \$4,581,000 in 2019.

Total gross through four nights is now \$51,407,000 with 148 yearlings to sell tonight in the final session.

Through four sessions, the sale is averaging a record \$71,898. That's up 27 per cent from the 2020 average through four sessions of \$56,495 and up 5 per cent from the record fourth-session average of \$68,738 in 2019. The median through four days is \$47,000. Last year it was \$37,000 through four sessions.

"The train is rolling along just like it has been," said Reid. "Tonight, I thought the energy was very good again. We had

new faces come into town. Tonight was where technology takes over a bit – the online bidding ramped up and 17 per cent of the horses sold tonight were sold online. A lot of people were here earlier in the week and did their inspections, then had to go home or go race horses. You got new faces that came in today for the weekend. You have people looking horses for their clients or agents for trainers that are remote or bidding online.

"The live factor here, there was good energy, good crowd and then you put in the online, there's really no reason you can't buy the horses. Whether near or far, you can do that."

SESSION TOPPER GOES FOR \$200,000

Friday's sale topper was hip 624 Kountry Jon, a Father Patrick colt out of Caddie In Love S sold by Anvil and Lace for \$200,000 to Philip Scott of New Jersey.

Scott said deserved to be sold earlier in the sale because of his European pedigree.

"It's very well known in Europe. It definitely stood out on the fourth day here," Scott said. "We bought him for our barn with Trond Smedshammer. We had a couple of clients from Europe interested in the horse. First of all, the horse looks incredible and has an incredible pedigree, especially known for Europeans. Not as known over here, but he had Ready Express in the pedigree







and it's just tremendous.

"We were prepared to go to that limit. We kind of thought it would end up a little bit lower, but I'm just glad we got it.

"I would say that the others bidding against me were European trainers. I know a couple of the Swedish trainers were interested in the horse, as well."


Anvil and Lace's Beth Yontz said she was excited Kountry Jon went for \$200,000.

"I was hoping for six figures, but I didn't know that we could get there. So, \$200,000 was amazing," she said.

"I knew the Europeans would be on him, simply because of his bloodlines. I was disappointed when they put him on the fourth night, but I've talked to Randy Manges many times and if they want a horse they are going to find him – it doesn't matter what stall, what barn, what consignment, what hip number. So, when we got here and started showing there was a lot of European interest."

Kountry Jon was one of two yearlings to sell for \$100,000 or more during Friday's session, meaning the total of \$100,000+ yearlings through four sessions is 152, which compares to 101 through four nights in 20201, 121 through four nights in 2019 and 124 through four nights in 2018.

Hip 683 American Cruiser, an American Ideal colt out of Lady Captain, sold for \$140,000 to Megan Scran, agent for Greg Luther, out of the Brittany Farms consignment.

TOP CONSIGNORS

Preferred Equine continues to lead all consignors in gross sales through four sessions with \$7,685,000 earned for 127 sold. Hunterton is second with \$7,041,000 for 68 sold. Kentuckiana is third with \$6,171,000 for 85 sold. Preferred (\$565,000) and Hunterton (\$554,000) led all consignors on Friday night.

By average, Concord Stud leads through four days (\$186,429), followed by Hanover Shoe Farms (\$155,100) and Brittany Farms (\$125,429).

Through four sessions, Nancy Takter is still the sale's leading buyer despite not buying any yearlings on Friday. She has spent \$2,907,000 to take home 12 yearlings. Tony Alagna spent \$419,000 to buy six yearlings on Friday and jumped over Steve Heimbecker into second place overall with \$2,605,000, total, spent on 24 yearlings. Heimbecker has spent \$2,342,000, in all, on 19 yearlings.

Tonight's fifth and final session of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale will feature 148 yearlings mostly from Ohio and Indiana. It begins tonight at 7 p.m. at Fasiq-Tipton.

"Similar to last year, you're going to have good energy here," Reid said. "There's a lot of nice horses, some regional program horses... Downbytheseaside is a regional sire, but has also proven to be a Grand Circuit sire, which is a great thing for the sport.

"It's going to be a good night. There's a big day of racing tomorrow and we'll just look to conclude a very good weekend of the Lexington experience – sales, racing. The weather was beautiful today and I'm excited to come in tomorrow night and start the show."

At 70, Don Irvine, Jr. not slowing down

Reinsman looking for a big night tonight at Hollywood Gaming at Dayton Raceway in the Ohio Fairs Championships.

Despite turning 70 years of age back in February, driver Don Irvine, Jr. has put together another successful season with a .293 Universal Drivers Rating featuring 80 wins and just shy of \$500,000 in earnings.

Irvine has five chances to add to his 2021 totals in the \$320,000 (div.) Ohio Fairs Championships tonight (Oct. 9) at Hollywood Gaming at Dayton Raceway.

The Ohio Fair Championships brings together the top nine points earners from the 65 Ohio county and independent fairs across the Buckeye state.

The septuagenarian looks to start the night off with a bang in race #1— the 2-year-old filly trot, drawing the rail with the 5-2 morning line choice, Hitwiththequy's.

Irvine is very familiar with Hitwiththeguy's as he drove her eight times this season, recording seven wins and a second-place finish.

"She's the one horse that I didn't want to draw the rail with," said Irvine. "She's a little erratic behind the gate. She hasn't made a break since her first couple of starts. It's my job to make sure she gets out on the trot. If she does, she'll have a big shot."

Hitwiththeguy's is the daughter of Hitwiththeladies, a little known and used stallion that had only 15 registered foals during his first seven years at stud. Hitwiththeguy's has a 9-1-0 record in 12 starts and has earned \$23,379 for trainer and owner Sue Stockwell.


Irvine was listed on three colts in the freshman colt trot, all trained by Rosy Weaver. He selected A Handsome Face (Post #6; 7-2) over A True Dream (Post #4; 6-1) and Rose Run Exalted (Post #7; 5-2).

Irvine has driven A Handsome Face in all 12 of his seasonal starts. They have teamed up for seven wins in his last nine starts, including a \$17,500 leg of Buckeye Stallion Series at the Champaign County Fair in Urbana on Aug. 10.

Weaver co-owns the Dejarmbro gelding with Willis Troyer's Heartland Acres.

"It probably looks like I didn't take the right horse. Rose Run Exalted looks like the best one out of the three. Mr. Troyer, who buys all of these babies for Rosy who co-owns her, so I picked that one.

"I think all three, depending how the race falls, have a good shot to win," Irvine, Jr. said.



The Weaver-Irvine duo will send Elegant Gigi (Post #4; 5/2) out in the \$40,000 3-year-old filly trot.

Elegant Gigi is a winner of six straight races at Mount Gilead, Canfield, Wooster, Delaware, Dover and Coshocton. The Delaware win was in the fifth leg of the Buckeye Stallion Series, earning her a spot in next weekend's \$60,000 BSS Final at MGM Northfield Park.

"She's got a real good shot. She has a couple to beat, but she's really sharp right now. I know that," said Irvine.

Her lifetime mark of 1:55.2 came in the Summit County Fair races at MGM Northfield Park on July 30.

Weaver owns the Dejarmbro filly, who has been consistent all season from April through October.

Irvine will conclude his night with a pair of 3-year-pacers for trainer Herman Hagerman.

Filet Mignon (Post #1; 8-1) will have the rail in the \$40,000 filly pace. The Racing Hill filly has been on the board in 17 of 22 starts this season. She is owned by Charles K. Reeve.

In the sophomore colt pace, Irvine will be behind Yankee Keeler (Post #5; 9/2).

The homebred Yankee Cruiser gelding has recorded six wins and has earned \$39,261 this season for A Piece Of The Action LLC.

"He's a little over his head. He's a good county fair horse and gets around those small fair tracks well, but the horse on the rail (King's Cruiser with driver Tyler Smith) should lay over the field," said Irvine.

Despite tonight's results, Irvine has shown great longevity during his 50-year career.

The native of Mt. Gilead, OH has secured more than 7,500 career wins and \$38.4 million in earnings.

He was the six-time driving champ at MGM Northfield Park (1970s and 1980s), had six additional titles at Harrah's Hoosier Park (1990s and 2000s) and added a couple more at a pair of Maryland tracks — Freestate Raceway and Rosecroft Raceway.

Irvine's success at Northfield secured him the honor of being an MGM Northfield Park Wall of Fame inductee in 1991.

On Aug. 23, Irvine recorded seven wins on the 14-race Lorain County Fair card.

"That is the most I ever won at a fair. I won nine at Northfield one night. I won eight or nine once over in Maryland," said Irvine. "That was a good day for a guy 70-year-old."

Some great messages received

I received a wonderful email this week from Mr. Peter Denmen, of Launceston, Tasmania, an island state in Australia.

Mr. Denmen called to my attention the 2-year-old pacing filly, Wolverina, who had just won a \$30,000 Massachusetts Sire Stake at Plainridge in 1:54.4. For the record, Wolverina is owned by Michael Graffam and William Arnold, trained by Michael Graffam, and driven by Nicholas Graffam. Her win on Oct. 4 was her fifth win of the season, a record that speaks for itself.

But the reason Wolverina caught Mr. Denmen's eye was her pedigree. She is by Cheyenne Hollywood, by Western Hanover, out of Terri I Fra, by Western Ideal, who's also by Western Hanover.

That makes the filly inbred 2 by 3 to Western Hanover and also inbred 3 by 3 to Artsplace, as well as linebred 4 by 4 by 4 to Abercrombie. Wolverina to date has done all her racing on the Massachusetts circuit, but you have to think her potential could make her a threat where the lights are brighter. And afterwards, she will be a very desirable broodmare.

Wolverina is just one more example of the synergy close breeding can produce. For those wanting a definition of synergy, think two plus two equals seven. I also have to thank Mr. Denmen for sharing his knowledge with me. Clearly, a distance of a great many miles is no barrier to his knowledge of American racing and breeding.

This kid also had the pleasure of a brief conversation at the sale grounds with one of my long-time friends, Myron Bell. Myron and I pretty much talked past each other on the subject of a sire's importance in a yearling's pedigree.

To be clear, I do think the present format of sales pedigrees pays short shrift to the yearling's sire when all he gets is a mention of his name. However, Myron's certainly right that a yearling's maternal line is the essential element in evaluating a yearling's desirability for purchase. It's also the determining factor in evaluating any mare, whether for breeding or racing purposes.

The only category in which the pedigree is irrelevant comes when evaluating a horse's future sire potential. This is heresy to many, but as far as Jim Harrison and this kid are concerned, each stallion is an entity unto himself, and his pedigree contributes nothing.

Now we are again getting into the subject of the phenotype, or the visible horse, versus the genotype, or the horse's genetic makeup. There is no way to know with any certainty whether a stallion will be a sire or not, but for me, and the great Italian breeder, Federico Tesio, the best indication we have is two-year-old brilliance on the track.

Until now, I have used the example of Muscle Mass, who was a stakes colt at 2, did bupkes at 3, and is one of the best sires out there today.

But now there's an even better example in Walner. At 2 he was invincible, winning everything, including the Breeders Crown by open lengths. He was the unquestionable Two-Year-Old Trotting Champion.

However, at 3, Walner made only two starts, and that was all she wrote. And today, with his first crop racing at 2, Walner is the leading money winning sire. Which his great racing record at 2 clearly foreshadowed.

Here, a personal note regarding a great sire. When Muscle Hill was laying up at the Red Mile as a 3-year-old, his groom was good enough to lead him out so I could get a good look at him.

Afterwards, someone asked me what I thought of the way he stood. They were puzzled when I said I never looked at the way he stood. To me, that was irrelevant. Any horse who could virtually go undefeated through all the major stakes at both 2 and 3 obviously stood well enough to be a great trotter. To me, that was all that counted.

What I saw, and still vividly remember about Muscle Hill, was his beautiful, sculpted head, his full, bright eyes, and the way he used his ears. That, and his great race record, was all I needed to know about Muscle Hill to feel he would be a top sire, and I was right.

More recently, when I mentioned to a fellow breeder that I liked Captain Corey as a sire prospect, he replied that he didn't like the way he stood. Any horse who can win the Hambletonian wire-to-wire stands just fine in my book.

A quick digression back to the pacing filly, Wolverina. I'm designating her as the first winner of the annual I'm My Own Grandpa award. For those unfamiliar with this great piece of American music, I'm My Own Grandpa goes through innumerable verses detailing complicated family relationships until it finally produces the song's title. I would have liked to print the song's lyrics in this space, but there are just too many verses. In any case, Wolverina is now the first winner of this award, and in all seriousness, I wish her and her connections all the best, along with my congrats for having come up with such a good filly.

Now, off to the sale, with fingers and toes tightly crossed. And in the plagiarized words of The Godfather, keep your friends close, and breed your mares closer.

Frozen in time

The problem of (not) allowing artificial insemination from deceased sires.

Steelhead Hanover (p, 5, 1:48.3; \$577,450) stood almost one season at stud, resulting in 25 live foals from 32 mares bred. Sadly, the Bettors Delight son would not survive an emergency surgery and was humanely euthanized in May 2017, before some offspring were even sired. Yes, you read that correctly.

Twenty sons and daughters of the single-season Meridian Farms stallion would make it to the races, with his sons making particular impact. Every Maritime track record for 2-year-old male pacers is currently held by a Steelhead Hanover gelding; four regional track records for 3-year-old geldings (and one all-age track record) are also owned by his progeny.

Dr. Martha Annie Mellish works in equine theriogenology at the Atlantic Veterinary College in Charlottetown, PEI. She is a 2005 AVC graduate with additional specialized training in reproductive medicine. Familiar with Steelhead Hanover, she is a proponent of extending a stallion's reproductive life through artificial insemination (A.I.) using frozen semen.

"It is something that requires closer veterinary management around the time of breeding if you use frozen semen," she said. "It is a very good option for mare owners... For the stakes program in PEI, the stallion has to have been alive in the last year for [his frozen semen] to be used posthumously. The foals are the same genetics as if from stallions that were alive."

Whether a stallion dies, is injured or gelded, or is geographically inaccessible, his fresh semen can be cryopreserved for the future. (Epididymal collection even allows for semen to be retrieved immediately post-mortem). Mellish said additives and liquid nitrogen keep it viable in a glass-like form.

"That's how it's held in suspended animation until it's time to breed the mare," she said.

Insemination with frozen semen is more labor-intensive than insemination with fresh or chilled semen.

"It just doesn't live as long in the reproductive tract because it's gone through the process of being centrifuged and being processed and then it's on liquid nitrogen," said the veterinarian, who works with broodmares undergoing the process at AVC. "It should be used within six hours of when the mare has ovulated, so you check them every six hours... Somebody will





bring their mare in close to the time of when she needs to be bred, and then we will actually ultrasound them every six hours through the night, so that we can precisely time when they're being inseminated."

Standardbreds are just one of the breeds whose registries permit artificial insemination with frozen semen and registration of the resulting foals. Mellish said it's not uncommon.

"We bred over 35 mares this spring at the [veterinary] school with frozen semen: quarter horses, warmbloods, arabs. A lot of different breed registries allow it."

Although she estimated that it's roughly double the cost of A.I. using fresh or chilled semen, there's definite demand for A.I. with frozen semen from specific stallions, usually non-shuttle horses at stud internationally.

The equine reproductive specialist worked closely with the ill-fated PEI standardbred whose offspring now dominate regional stakes and record books.

"In the case of Steelhead Hanover, in 2017, he was euthanized and died partway through the breeding season," she told HRU. "We were able to harvest some of his semen and use it on mares for the rest of the breeding season, so kind of carry out the rest of that breeding season... The semen was harvested from his testicles shortly before he was euthanized, and then it was able to be used for the rest of the season... It resulted in Woodmere Stealdeal [p,3,1:52.1h; \$123,078], who as a 2-year-old won all of the [Maritime] stakes races. He wouldn't be around without frozen semen breeding."

Offspring of a deceased sire don't face sales-ring stigma about that fact.

"If anything, they're more valuable because they're harder to get," said Mellish. She told HRU that although frozen semen is "good for at least 20 years after" it's preserved at -196 degrees Celsius, it does result in "probably a 20 per cent lower conception rate" that varies by the individual horse.

"Some stallions are just as fertile with frozen as with fresh or shipped, cooled semen, and then some stallions don't freeze very well at all," she explained, adding that these tendencies tend to run in families, but not always. "A lot of the time, you have to freeze it, thaw a bit of it out and actually breed the mare, see how it does."

Posthumous use of frozen standardbred semen poses a conundrum. Mellish observed that prohibitions aren't based on biological or technological limitations.

"There are no scientific reasons that I know. You know, there's [also] no real reason why a mare couldn't have multiple foals in a year using embryo transfer, but it's restricted by the breed registries and I guess there must be an economic reason for that."

Preventing a single, popular stallion from monopolizing a breed's gene pool is one argument for not allowing a deceased horse's frozen semen to be used indefinitely after his death. "I guess that potentially could be a risk, but you do hope that breeders would see younger stallions, newer genetics coming up, as better," she continued. "That you would allow the breed's genetics to progress. We certainly haven't seen [monopolies by deceased sires] in other breeds that do allow the indefinite use of frozen semen."

The limited time window for using frozen standardbred semen raises more questions when a promising young sire's career ends prematurely. Mellish said she would like to see a longer time frame in which the horse's semen can be used.

"Absolutely. [Steelhead Hanover] was a younger stallion, so he didn't have progeny performance before he passed away, and you don't know how they're going to perform, right? But say we were allowed to use frozen semen from him and we had a bank of it, if this rule was in place, you could have that as an insurance policy."

She agreed that Somebeachsomewhere (euthanized in 2018) and Cam Fella (gelded in 1997 due to testicular cancer) are others whose direct, cryopreserved genetic contribution would remain popular if the rules allowed for it.

They usually do not.

In the USTA rulebook, section 26.05 states that while foals "conceived by transported fresh or frozen semen shall be eligible for registration," their sire must be a living or recently-deceased stallion: "In the event of the castration or death of a stallion no foal conceived by semen from that stallion in a year after said death or castration is eligible for registration." Ontario rules specify that for foals to be considered Ontario-sired, "frozen

semen must be used in a year that the stallion is registered with the program. If the stallion dies during a breeding season, the frozen semen can only be used to finish that breeding season."

British and Irish standardbred rules allow it.

"Frozen semen from a deceased stallion may be used, providing a DNA profile of the stallion is available." But in Australia, regulations changed to end the practice last year, grandfathering (grandsiring?) in a provision to accommodate breeders with older frozen semen. Rule 285A now states that semen "from an Australian registered sire which has died or disappeared or been gelded shall... only be used in the breeding season in which the sire has died or disappeared or been gelded or the next breeding season" and "do not apply to a registered standardbred which has prior to 1 September, 2020 died, disappeared or been gelded."

In PEI, there's no shortage of quality trotting or pacing stallions. This keeps demand for frozen standardbred semen lower than for horses without this local advantage.

"It certainly is growing in other breeds, from what we see," said Mellish. "This is in the category of advanced reproductive techniques, ART, and that is only growing around the world. Embryo transfer, frozen semen breeding, or what is called ICSI [intracytoplasmic sperm injection] breeding in horses [i.e. fertilizing the egg outside the mare]. That's rapidly expanding in the rest of the world."

It seems that tradition and economics, not science, are the rationale for frozen semen being unusable long before its biological expiry date. Case in point: Although originally frozen to meet demand for export in his lifetime, Trakenher stallion Abdullah's cryopreserved semen was still in use more than a decade after the 1984 Olympic showjumping champion's death in 2000.

What about the descendants of Hambletonian 10? Should the usable lifespan of frozen semen continue beyond the death of the sire?

"I wouldn't have a reservation about that at all, honestly, and I think it does open up the possibility for deceased stallions to be used to allow for the best matching between mares and stallions," said Mellish.

Sunday (Oct. 10) at Red Shores Charlottetown, when the Atlantic Breeders Crown 3-year-old colt pacing final goes behind the gate, four of the seven starters will represent the late Steelhead Hanover. His genetic legacy is likely frozen in time: Like all but two of his male offspring, top sons Woodmere Stealdeal, Dustylanegoliath, Steel Reefer, and Jadensmagicsteel are geldings.





Branded By Lindy on top in International Stallion Stakes

Sent the odds-on choice, **Branded By Lindy** lunged by his competition, including Peter Haughton champ King Of The North, to post a 1:53.2 victory in taking the first of four divisions for the \$302,000 Six Pack International Stallion Stake 2-Year-Old Colt & Gelding Trot on Friday (Oct. 8) at Red Mile.

Letsdoit S shot for the lead to a :28.4 first quarter while the two favorites lagged behind the leaders in a positional stalemate

that eventually settled with King Of The North fronting Branded By Lindy towards the back. The pair recouped lost ground to a :56.3 half, where driver Yannick Gingras flushed cover for Branded By Lindy from King Of The North and rode a steady tow towards the front around the final turn.

Gigondas circled to lead the field into the final turn and maintained control to three-quarters in 1:26.1 with King Of The North gradually gaining on the outside. Though Gingras angled Branded By Lindy to the center of the course off the turn and promptly surged by his competition to win by a length past the beam. Letsdoit S shot through an opening at the pylons for second while King Of The North settled for third and Gigondas faded to fourth.

"He's like racing a 4-year-old really," Gingras said after the race. "He's really mature and you can do whatever you want with him. He's obviously got the ability, the speed, but just being able to race him any which way you want, that's what makes him so strong. He had more left.

"Mark [MacDonald and King Of The North] was backing up to try to get me in front of him, but that wasn't going to happen. But it wasn't going to happen. I wanted to follow him. He's a

great horse, King Of The North, and I figured he'd get me where I need to go. I was just hoping to be a couple lengths off at the top of the stretch and I thought he could get the job done from there. Like I said, I'm really impressed by him, I trusted him and he got the job done easily."

Winning his seventh race from nine starts, Branded By Lindy has banked \$143,350 for owner/breeder Lindy Farms of Connecticut. Domenico Cecere trains the son of Chapter Seven who paid \$3.80 to win.

Several of the top betting interests in the second split of the Six Pack went on gallops, but **World At War Deo** stayed flat and in a striking spot to pounce and score in a 1:54.1 mile.

Keg Stand kicked off the car and quickly jumped off stride to the first turn while Rose Run Xtra slotted in behind early leader World At War Deo. Rose Run Xtra then moved for the lead through a :28 first quarter as Stride The Hill broke stride from fourth. He led unchallenged through a :56.4 half while Tachyon tipped first over and carried Classic Hill second over to the final turn.

Rose Run Xtra's advantage narrowed to three-quarters in 1:26.2 as Tachyon upped the pressure and Classic Hill fanned off cover before he then broke stride through the stretch. Tachyon took over a short lead as Rose Run Xtra drifted and faded between horses, but World At War Deo shot through the developed gap to the inside and coasted to a length victory over closing Majestic J to the finish. Tachyon took third and Rose Run Xtra settled

for fourth.

Owned by Steve Heimbecker, Blue Chip Bloodstock Inc., Michael Guerriero and Menary Racing Inc., World At War Deo collected his fourth win from 10 starts, earning \$97,697. Dave Menary trains the son of Chapter Seven who returned \$10 to win.



Rebuff rolled off a helmet to a comfortable 1-1/2-length victory in the third split of the Six Pack as the odds-on choice in a 1:52.2 effort.

Periculum pushed for the front to a :28.3 first quarter with Villain sitting the pocket and Fast As The Wind in third. Rebuff raced fifth to the backside and managed to grab cover from Pretender to a :56.1 half, ranging to within two lengths of the lead to three-quarters in 1:24.2. Driver Tim Tetrick launched Rebuff off cover at the bottom of the turn and darted to the lead as Periculum scooted up the pylons to give pursuit through the final eighth, though settling for second to the finish. Global Pandemic rallied for third and Pretender held fourth.

Co-owned by trainer Lucas Wallin with Kjell Andersen and Pieter Delis, Rebuff won his second race from nine starts, earning \$131,595. The Muscle Hill colt paid \$3.60 to win.

The final split of the Six Pack went to **Temporal Hanover**, who tipped out of the pocket and cruised home a 1:53.2 winner.

Grabbing command to a :29 first quarter, Temporal Hanover yielded control up the backside to 1-5 favorite Slay, who then took the field to the half in :56.4. Temporal Hanover stayed put until the bottom of the final bend when driver Brian Sears inched the Walner colt out of second by three-quarters in 1:25.3 and swiftly put away Slay through the straightaway. B A Superhero took second in a photo with Slay, beaten 4-1/4 lengths, with Golden Wall As finishing third.

"He's been racing well all year," trainer Marcus Melander said after the race. "He was a little bit sick in the final of the William Wellwood, but he's always showed up."

Owned by AMG Stable Inc., Kenneth Kjellgren, Rick Wahlstedt and Heights Stable, Temporal Hanover won his fifth race from 10 starts, earning \$198,666. He paid \$8.80 to win.

Each division of the Six Pack International Stallion Stakes was sponsored by the Six Pack Syndicate and Deo Volente Farms.

Niki Hill stays undefeated with Stallion Stakes score

Despite staying parked when pressing for the lead around the final turn, Chris Ryder trainee **Niki Hill** powered to the lead and strode to a 1:51.2 win in the first of two divisions for the \$254,000 American Ideal International Stallion Stakes 2-Year-Old Filly Pace to remain unbeaten from six starts.

The Always B Miki filly landed in fourth while Sloopy set the pace to a :28.2 first quarter and soon yielded control up the backside to Cape Cod Hanover, who anxiously vacated the cones and swept to the top before a :56.4 half. Driver Dexter Dunn floated Niki Hill first over moving to the final turn with Lyons Serenity in tow and rolled to nearly clear the lead. Cape Cod Hanover accelerated to the inside and kept her wide to three-quarters in 1:25.1 but Niki Hill surged back to the lead off the turn with a wall of horses charging from behind. Queen

Of Success stormed from third over to snag second, beaten two lengths, with A Girl That Twirls closing for third and Lyons Serenity finishing fourth.

"We had a minor hiccup before we qualified her – she got a stone bruise in her foot," trainer Chris Ryder said after the race. "We weren't really concerned about it because a stone got literally caught in her foot and bruised her up. I'm a lot happier to have six starts instead of nine or 10 by now because we have a couple races at the end of the year we want to concentrate on."

Niki Hill paid \$2.10 to win as she extended her unbeaten record while upping her bankroll to \$322,064 for owner Tom Hill.

A heated tempo poised 43-1 shot **Frantasy Hanover** to fire down the center of the course and nail her stablemate at the beam in the other division of the American Ideal, stopping the clock in 1:51.2.

Southwind Java sped off the wings for the front with Galleria Hanover settling into second to a :27 first quarter. Galleria Hanover soon vacated the pocket to the backside and circled to the top as Dont Fence Me In got underway out of fourth and marched to clear the lead past a :54.4 half. Yes And Yes, the 4-5 favorite, followed her move and raced uncovered into the final turn, pressing pacesetter Dont Fence Me In to three-quarters in 1:22.1.

Off the turn, Dont Fence Me In started to tire as Yes And Yes forged to the lead. But Frantasy Hanover, racing last through the mile, came widest of all and charged with open racetrack ahead for the lead to get a nose up just in time over Yes And Yes. Dont Fence Me In held third and Galleria Hanover took fourth.

"This filly here, obviously we really didn't know [what she had]," winning driver Joe Bongiorno said after the race of the Ron Burke pupil. "She was a long shot in this race. [Ronnie] did say she would be good, but she's got to step up to go with these horses today and that's just what she did."

Paying \$89.60, Frantasy Hanover, a filly by Always B Miki, scored her second victory from six starts, earning \$74,218 for owner Christopher Nicol.

Each division of the American Ideal International Stallion Stakes was sponsored by the American Ideal Syndicate and Brittany Farms.

Racing resumes at Red Mile today (Oct. 9) with stakes action including the \$314,000 International Moni International Stallion Stakes for 2-year-old trotting fillies and the \$289,900 Tall Dark Stranger International Stallion Stakes for 2-year-old pacing colts and geldings.

Sunday's card will feature a tribute to the late champion trainer Ron Gurfein, who passed away in May of this year. The memorial for Gurfein will be held after the second race, with horsemen leaving the paddock to come to the front stretch for a moment of silence and a memorial video.

First-race post time at Red Mile is 1 p.m. (EDT).



Kentucky Futurity tops 2021 closer to Red Mile meet

Grand Circuit competition at The Red Mile will wrap on Sunday (Oct. 10) in a stakes-ladened 12-race card capped by the 129th edition of the Kentucky Futurity, which goes for a purse of \$561,000 and is sponsored by Hunterton Farms, Stoner Manor Inc. and Menhammar Stuteri AB.

A 12-horse dash aligns for the Kentucky classic. Trainer Ake

Svanstedt again comes with a strong contingent despite the absence of Hambletonian winner Captain Corey, who sustained a season-ending injury in late summer. He sends a battalion of five – Fly Light (post 3), Mon Amour (post 4), Delayed Hanover (post 7), Ambassador Hanover (post 9) and Johan Palema (post 12). Between them, Fly Light and Mon Amour have wins over The Red Mile in Bluegrass action last week, Delayed Hanover set a world record over this track as a 2-year-old, Ambassador Hanover finished third in the Hambletonian and Johan Palema won the Yonkers Trot back in June.

The field for the Futurity also includes Dancinginthedark M and Cuatro De Julio, who finished one-two in the Kentucky Championship final on Sept. 19. Dancinginthedark M starts as part of a three-pronged attack for conditioner Marcus Melander; his other entrants are In Range (post 8) and Sonofamistery (post 10). Brian Sears pilots Dancinginthedark M from the pylon post, directly inside of Cuatro De Julio in rein to Lucas Wallin for conditioner Marie Ortolan Bar.

Really Fast and Ahundreddollarbill, the latter of which supplemented for \$75,000, come into the Futurity attempting to rebound. Really Fast will try to return to the early season promise he showed following several tough luck miles in the Kentucky Championship Series, though he enters this event off a closing second-place finish in the Bluegrass. Canadian Trotting Classic champ Ahundreddollarbill travelled a wide trip in the Bluegrass but finished one paced over the "slop" to finish third.

Ahundreddollarbill's regular pilot, Andrew McCarthy, will take another assignment in sticking with trainer Greg Wright Jr. and his pupil Jujubee, who entered the event through a \$75,000 supplemental fee. The Pennsylvania Sires Stakes champ emerged onto the national stake scene on Hambletonian day with an explosive pocket pop that stopped the clock in 1:49.4 and lands post 5 in the overflow field.

The sister event to the afternoon's feature, the 56th Kentucky Filly Futurity, also draws an overflow field and is sponsored by Crawford Farms. Hambletonian Oaks winner Bella Bellini lands post 5 for trainer Richard "Nifty" Norman and driver Dexter Dunn off a second-place finish in the \$327,060 Elegantimage final at Woodbine Mohawk Park. She competes in a group that includes Ohio Sires Stakes champ Herculisa from post 1 (a \$50,000 supplement to the race), Kentucky Championship winner Empressive Hill from post 10, Bluegrass split runner-up You Ato Dream and Contested Hanover from posts 6 and 12 respectively, and Buckette winner Pub Crawl from post 7. Katie's Lucky Day, starting from post 11, also supplemented into this event for \$50,000 and enters off a third-place finish in the Elegantimage.

Pacing sophomores star alongside the trotting classic starters in a pair of events – the \$500,000 Tattersalls Pace for the glamour boys and the \$207,000 Glen Garnsey Memorial for the gals. The Tattersalls Pace, sandwiched between the futurities to the tail of the card and sponsored by the Cameo Hills Farm, rematches Joe Holloway's star Perfect Sting against a duo of stout competitors – Little Brown Jug champ Lou's Pearlman from post 3

and Bluegrass champ Charlie May from post 12, the latter of which supplemented into this event for \$60,000. Perfect Sting lands post 4 in the 12-horse event as he tries to upend two horses who have bested him this season. The field also includes Bluegrass split winner Southwind Gendry from post 2 and a pair of runner-up performers in Abuckabett Hanover from post 9 and Rockyroad Hanover from post 11.

Test Of Faith makes her first start from millionaire's row in the Tattersalls Pace Glen Garnsey Memorial, though she scores from post 9 in the 10-horse affair. David Miller pilots the winner of 18 from 21 starts against a group including Richard "Nifty" Norman's pair of tenacious fillies in Fire Start Hanover (post 3) and Grace Hill (Post 8) as well as Ron Burke's speedster Blue Diamond Eyes (post 5). The Glen Garnsey is sponsored by the Downbytheseaside Syndicate and Diamond Creek Farms.

Older competition also hits the track on Sunday starting with the \$81,000 What The Hill Allerage Farms Filly and Mare Trot, sponsored by the What The Hill Syndicate and Hickory Lane Farm. Speedy sophomore Altar lands against the older mares after supplementing for \$8,550 from post 4 for trainer Nancy Takter and driver Dexter Dunn and faces two Hambletonian and two Hambletonian Oaks winners. Atlanta, the 2018 Hambletonian champ, starts from post 5 with Yannick Gingras driving for trainer Ron Burke and 2020 Hambletonian winner Ramona Hill starts from post 9, which will be her first start since making a break in the Hambletonian Maturity on July 17. When Dovescry, the 2019 Oaks champ, starts from post 2 while Sorella, 2020 Oaks winner, starts from post 10.


European star Ecruie D DK finally lands stateside with his first North American start coming in the \$134,000 E L Titan Allerage Farms Trot, sponsored by Blue Chip Farms LLC and Emp Invest Oy. Ake Svanstedt assumes training of the 5-year-old Infinitif stallion from conditioner Frode Hamre and will also steer the star from post 6 against stablemate and Dayton Trotting Derby champ Back Of The Neck and 2019 Hambletonian winner Forbidden Trade among five other strong competitors.

Team Noble's Ocean Rock will try to keep the rock rolling into the \$158,000 Allerage Farms Pace, having won in his last four starts which includes the \$135,000 Jim Ewart Memorial, \$182,000 Hoosier Park Pacing Derby and the \$168,000 Dayton Pacing Derby. Dan Noble drives the gelding by Rockin Amadeus from post 3 against the likes of three millionaires – This Is The Plan (post 5), Catch The Fire (post 6) and Cattlewash (post 9) – as well as a pair of speedy 4-year-olds in Tattoo Artist (post 8) and Allywag Hanover (post 10). The Allerage Farms Pace is sponsored by Jeff & Paula Gural.

Rocknificent's time in the sun may finally come in the \$73,500 Woodbine Mohawk Park Allerage Farms Filly and Mare Pace with her main rival through the season, Lyons Sentinel, absent. The Linda Toscano trainee has completed the exacta to Lyons Sentinel in five of her 15 starts this season and now starts from post 1 in rein to Scott Zeron against five other mares, two of which come from conditioner Nancy Takter in Peaky Sneaky (post 2) and JK First Lady (post 6).

First-race post time for the final card of the Grand Circuit fortnight is 1 p.m. (EDT).

'Classy' Metro champ Monte Miki set for International Stallion

Monte Miki might not have been a head turner at the time of his birth, but, oh, look at him now. The unbeaten colt is garnering plenty of admiring looks following his win in the season's most lucrative event for 2-year-old pacers, the Metro Pace, and returns to the races today (Oct. 9) in the third of three International Stallion Stakes divisions for freshman male pacers at Red Mile.

A homebred son of Always B Miki out of Montenegro, Monte Miki is owned by Ohio's Velocity Standardbreds, which is headed by Sylvia Norris, and is trained by her husband Mark Evers. The colt is 4-for-4 this year with earnings of \$341,580.

It was Evers' admiration for Montenegro, who was a top-level performer at Harrah's Hoosier Park, that led him to purchase her for \$57,000 at the 2016 Standardbred Horse Sale's Mixed Sale and begin her broodmare career.

"I had a healthy respect for her when we raced against her at Hoosier Park," Evers said. "I had wanted her for a few years, and when she was sent to Harrisburg (for the sale) I was going to get her no matter what. We were glad to get her."

Monte Miki was her first foal.

And Evers laughs when recalling his first impression of the colt. "When I delivered him, I told my wife he's an ugly baby," Evers

said. "He was so big and ugly. But he came out of it. He prettied right up. He has a classy look. He's just a classy colt, big and black and good looking. I just like everything about him. Knowing who is mother was, I expected him to do well and to be a good colt. And it's turned out."

Josh Sutton drove Monte Miki in his first three races, all at Scioto Downs in conditioned events for 2-year-olds. The third victory, in 1:52 from post eight following a layoff because of sickness, solidified Evers' belief the colt was ready to go to Canada for the \$650,960 Metro Pace.

"Josh told us this colt is a gorilla, he's just playing," Evers told Roger Huston recently on the Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association podcast *Top of the Stretch*. "He won in (1):52 and was still flicking his ears and looking around. So, we decided to go with it."

Scott Zeron was in the sulky for the Metro, where Monte Miki started from post 11 in the second tier of the 12-horse field. The colt was 10th at the half and faced traffic woes all around until Bob Loblaw went off stride entering the final turn and provided an opening. Zeron pounced on the opportunity, advanced three-wide heading into the stretch, and guided Monte Miki to a 2-3/4 length win in 1:52.2.

"It was a complete surprise to us," Evers said. "I thought he was the horse enough, but the way the race was going, I had my doubts. Finally, he shook loose and that was all he needed. Scott worked it out and got him through there. He did a great job."

Evers trained and drove Art's Chip, who missed out on advancing to the final of the 2003 North America Cup through the unluck of the draw as a third-place finisher in his elimination, and finished second to Ponder by a neck in the 2005 Canadian Pacing Derby. So, the Metro triumph with Monte Miki was particularly satisfying.

"I've always looked at the Metro, the Canadian Pacing Derby, and the North America Cup as three of the biggest races there are," Evers said. "To come back and win the Metro, it was quite a big deal for us. The money is great, but just to accomplish that was pretty neat. Long after the money is gone, you'll still be known and thinking about winning that."

Zeron returns to the sulky Saturday at Red Mile, where Monte Miki is the 5-2 morning-line favorite in a field of eight. Following the International Stallion Stakes, the colt will be pointed to the Breeders Crown at The Meadowlands.

"Just with what he's done already, I'm happy with him if he doesn't do anything else," Evers said. "Hopefully we can do some good these next few races. I don't want to be too confident, but I think he's got a good shot. But you need some racing luck, just like what happened in the Metro. You need a little bit of luck also."

Hanover Shoe Farms has announced that world champion Andover Hall has been retired from stallion duty. A foal of 1999, Andover Hall took his record of 1:51.3 at the age of 3 and earned over \$870,000. He was named the Dan Patch 2-year-old Trotting Colt of the Year in 2001. A freak paddock accident caused Andover Hall to be scratched from the final of the Breeders Crown at 3 and he would never race again.

Standing his first season in 2003, Andover Hall made an immediate splash in the trotting stallion ranks by siring Hambletonian winner and prominent stallion Donato Hanover 3,1:50.1 (\$2,998,777), champion filly Pampered Princess 3,1:53 (\$1,648,362) and millionaire Adrian Chip 3,1:54.2 (\$1,124,584) in his very first crop. Other standouts sired by Andover Hall include Elitloppet Winner Nuncio 3,1:50.4 (\$3,627,500), Creatine 1:51.2 (\$2,102,022), Magic Tonight 3,1:52.4f (\$1,362,296), Spider Blue Chip 3,1:51.3 (\$1,264,522), Cedar Dove 1:52.3 (\$1,178,930) and Beatgoeson Hanover (\$1,157,830).

Broodmare sire credits for Andover Hall include When Doves Cry 1:50 (\$1,471,272), Classic Martine 1:51.1 (\$1,168,161), Archangel 1:50 (\$1,140,572) and European star Propulsion 1:52.1 (\$920,029).

"Andover Hall has made a tremendous impact on the sport of trotting both through his sons and daughters and his legacy will live on for years to come" says Hanover's executive vice president Dr. Bridgette Jablonsky. "He has battled arthritis in his hocks for several years now and has reached the point where it is in his best interest to retire him and let him live out his years in his paddock next to his also retired buddy Cantab Hall. It has truly been an honor and privilege to stand Andover Hall for the entirety of his 18-year stallion career".

James MacDonald is riding a career-best year into the Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) post season. He will drive in all eight Grassroots Championship races at Woodbine Mohawk Park tonight (Oct. 9) and is the regular reinsman for five top three point earners headed towards next weekend's Super Finals.

"Geez, it's been such a good year. I just keep waiting for that slump of going 0 for 100 or something and I might have one bad night or one night where I don't win one, and I'm like, 'Oh, here it comes,' and the next night I win three or four," said MacDonald. "It's just been a special year for me and I've just been able to keep a hot streak going all year for some unknown reason. I've got so many good barns, and good trainers and owners I am driving for, and it makes my job so much easier. And I've been blessed with a really strong OSS group of horses to drive this year."

With a 47-point lead on five-time Lampman Cup winner Sylvain Filion and 51 up on last year's winner Bob McClure, MacDonald has a stranglehold on the 2021 Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) leading driver award. He has piloted 169 OSS starters to 41 wins, 27 seconds, 20 thirds and earnings of \$1,710,218 for a Lampman Cup point tally of 454. (Click **here** for complete Lampman Cup standings.)

Overall, MacDonald's 2021 campaign has seen him make 1240 appearances on the racetrack, engineering 231 wins, 188 seconds, 162 wins and \$5,608,113 in earnings through Oct. 7, which leads all drivers in Canada.

Among the horses that have been standouts for MacDonald this summer are a trio of Gold level 2-year-olds from the Millar Farms/Nick Gallucci barn, pacing fillies Prohibition Legal and Silver Label and pacing colt Betterhavemymoney. In this Saturday's Grassroots Championships he will steer a pair of well-regarded two-year-olds from the Shawn Steacy barn, pacing filly Semi-Final winner In The Mood and pacing colt Macho Phil, and the Guelph, ON resident said both the Gallucci and Steacy operations have been key contributors to his success this season.

"Obviously Millar Farms and Nick Gallucci and I had a spectacular season together, and hopefully we're not done and for years to come we can have more big years. And the Steacys, I am still driving quite a bit for Mark and Shawn. They've helped me grow as a driver over the years and I can't say enough good things about them and the things they've done for me," said MacDonald, who also drove a number of horses for his older brother Anthony MacDonald's fractional ownership enterprise **TheStable.ca**. "We butt heads and fight all the time, but I think he's just a terrific horseman and he doesn't get enough credit for what he does for the industry and for racing itself. Those people for sure, but I could go on all day about all the people that have helped me have such a great year."

While James is deeply appreciative of the people that have placed their faith in him this season, he said the most important ingredient has been the horses. One or two top horses can easily be the difference between a first Lampman Cup title or a sixth top five finish.


"Like I've said all year, any of the drivers at Mohawk, they're all superstars, if you give them the horses I am driving this year their name's going to be on the Lampman Cup," said James. "So it's an honor to be the top OSS driver, because there's so many good drivers here and it's such a deep roster of people, so to come out on top is really special and I am happy to be there."

In addition to freshman pacers Macho Phil (Post 5, Race 5) and In The Mood (Post 7, Race 8), MacDonald will also steer 2-year-old trotting filly Classic Magic (Post 6, Race 2), 3-year-old pacing filly Cyclone Sister (Post 8, Race 3), 2-year-old trotting gelding Marvin Hagler (Post 6, Race 4), 3-year-old trotting filly Rubys Are Nice (Post 10, Race 7), 3-year-old trotting gelding Four Wheelin (Post 3, Race 9) and 3-year-old pacing gelding Lord Anthony (Post 5, Race 10) in Saturday's Grassroots Championships.

Both Cyclone Sister and Four Wheelin will be looking to defend the Grassroots titles they captured as two-year-olds, a feat only five horses have been able to accomplish through the first 23 Championships.

The first race goes in behind the starting gate at 7 pm and the Grassroots Championships get under way in Race 2.
