Zacon Gio posts impressive International win for Italy

The victory was the 4-year-old's 12th consecutive win and the first outside his home nation.

Holger Ehlert has been buying and training trotters for most of his 55 years, long enough to know that pedigree is only one element to consider when evaluating a prospect.


For that reason, he did not hesitate to pay \$3,000 for a yearling by unproven stallion Ruty Grif out of the Yankee Glide dam May Glade Font SM. He thought he would take a shot with a youngster that came to be known as Zacon Gio.

Zacon Gio proved to be the horse of a lifetime, as well as the toast of Italy, when he dominated the \$1 million International Trot on Saturday (Oct. 12) at Yonkers Raceway for his 12th consecutive victory.

"The horse has been getting better and better and better," Ehlert said of the explosive 4-year-old, speaking through an interpreter. "We really don't know how much more he can do."

It was only the third triumph for Italy in the 41-year history of the International. The other Italian representatives to prevail were Delfo in 1977 and Twister Bi only two years ago. The United States has used home advantage to win more often than any other nation with 14 victories, closely followed by France with 12.

Zacon Gio (Roberto Vecchione) posted a stirring victory for Italy in Saturday's \$1 million Yonkers International Trot to push his undefeated streak to 12 races with his first win outside his home country.


The tradition-rich race began at old Roosevelt Raceway in 1959 and eventually went on a 20-year hiatus. It was revived by Tim Rooney five years ago, but faces an uncertain future following Rooney's sale of Yonkers Raceway to MGM Resorts at the end of January. Ed Domingo, senior vice president and chief financial officer for MGM, said the race must be evaluated from a business standpoint as well as its place in the history of the sport (full story here).

Giuseppe Franco purchased Zacon Gio for far more than Ehlert paid once the trotter started to show promise. "I've had many horses for many years," he noted, also assisted by an interpreter. "This particular horse, I knew there was something special about him."

Franco said the victory came at a good time because the industry has been struggling in Italy. Investment is needed from new owners.

"People won't feel discouraged," Franco said. "They will feel there is hope for them, too."

Zacon Gio showed impressive wins earlier this season, beating France's highly-regarded Face Time Bourbon in the Group 1 Premio Unione Europea and tacking on another Group 1, the Gran Premio Tino Triossi. He also had captured the Gran Premio Nello Bellei.

Still, he had never competed outside of Italy and not all trotters adapt well to the half-mile oval at Yonkers. It is not uncommon for top contenders to lose all hope early by breaking stride due to the suddenness and frequency of the turns.

It was therefore somewhat surprising to many onlookers when Zacon Gio was sent off as the even-money favorite against a superb mare such as Atlanta. The connections of the winner were not surprised, though.

"I didn't come here just to come here," said driver Roberto Vecchione, 55. "I came to win this."

Zacon Gio left early from post five in a classy field of 10 and quickly assumed a good striking position in fourth. Atlanta, a stellar mare driven by Yannick Gingras, was allowed to have things her way for much of the way. The opening quarter of a mile went in a slugglish :28.1, with the half in a very comfortable :59.

According to Vecchione, a winner of more than 5,000 races in his career, his biggest job was to keep his horse on hold.

"The horse was getting a little bit angry like, 'What are we going to do here? Are we going to race or are we going to jog?" he said.

Vechhione kept biding his time. "I was not worried," he said. "In the end, I know this horse is going to be there."

Indeed, Zacon Gio more than got there. He roared past

Atlanta, bidding to become the ninth mare to win the International and the first since the race was revived five years ago only to come up empty. The final time was 2:24:1. The winner paid \$4.30.

Zacon Gio won for the 21st time in 30 starts with two runner-up finishes and two third-place showings. He boosted his earnings to \$996,834.

"He's always playing. He's like a young horse," Vecchione said. "But when there is a race, he knows what to do."

Denmark's Slide So Easy placed second. Marion Marauder of Canada did well to be third despite soft fractions with the United States' Guardian Angel AS taking fourth. Sweden's Cruzado Dela Noche, the defending champion, could do no better than fifth.

Brad Grant, part of Atlanta's ownership group, admitted he was surprised by the way their mare packed it in.

"I thought she could have finished better, but something obviously wasn't right," Grant said. "We'll regroup and go from there."

Franco was asked if he would like to bring Zacon Gio back to Yonkers to defend his title if the race is continued. His emphatic "Yes!" did not require an interpreter.

Mission Accepted and McWicked win International undercard stakes

It was sort of a shame to refer to these as 'undercard events,' but favored **Mission Accepted** (Yannick Gingras, \$5.90) and **McWicked** (Brian Sears, \$6.90) were as advertised Saturday afternoon (Oct. 12), winning Yonkers Raceway's \$250,000 Harry Harvey and Dan Rooney Invitational Trot and Pace, respectively.

The Harvey saw Mission Accepted work out a perfect second-over sojourn behind Rich And Miserable (Tyler Buter). The latter, Eye Ofa Tiger AS (Jason Bartlett), Will Take Charge (Jordan Stratton) and Emoticon Hanover (Dan Dube) were all part of the early scrum in the mile-and-a-quarter event.

It was Will Take Charge who led through intervals of :28; :56.2 and 1:26, with Rich and Miserable out for a second move. The one engaged the leader in and out of the 1:54.4 mile marker, with Mission Accepted — from post position No. 2 — ready for his cue.

Reprising the International, the second-over was first, as Mission Accepted went wide and widened, winning by 2¾ lengths in an added-distance 2:23.4. An out-the-duration Custom Cantab (Dave Miller) was tremendous for second,



with a tiring Will Take Charge, Speeding Spur N (Brian Sears) and Eye of a Tiger AS settling for the minors.

For Mission Accepted, a 4-year-old son of Manofmanymissions—Witty Girl co-owned (as Burke Racing) by (trainer) Ron Burke, Weaver Bruscemi, Knox Services and David Willis, it was his fifth win in 20 seasonal starts. The exacta (two wagering choices) paid \$16.80, the triple paid \$60.50 and the superfecta paid \$440.

"He just overachieves," Gingras said. "I couldn't have asked for a better trip and he gives 120 per cent."

While pondering whether that's even possible, a word about McWicked... and that word, said with love, is freak.

Last season's Dan Rooney champ became this season's Dan Rooney champ, doing it the hard way.

Mission Accepted (Yannick Gingras) was dominant in the \$250,000 Harry Harvey.

McWicked ground down 9-5 choice Jimmy Freight (Scott Zeron), then held off Micky Gee N (Stratton) by a nostril in 1:51.1.

It was the 40th career win for McWicked.

From post No. 6, he was away fourth as Jimmy Freight two-moved around None Bettor A (Bartlett), throwing down a swift quick gauntlet (:26.2, 55.1, 1:22.4) along the way.

McWicked methodically moved toward the leader early in the lane, with Jimmy Freight giving way... albeit grudgingly. After Micky Gee N and Jimmy Freight, locals The Real One (Pat Lachance) and Theartofconfusion A (Austin Siegelman) picked off the leftovers.

For second choice McWicked, an 8-year-old son of

McArdle—Western Sahara owned by S S G Stables and trained by Casie Coleman, it was his sixth win in 15 2019 tries. The exacta paid \$74.50, the triple paid \$369.50 and the superfecta paid \$1,710.

"I was happy where I was able to get away and I knew I'd have to chase someone," Sears said. "I'm glad for him. He's battled foot issues during the summer and he's such a pleasure to drive. He's given me a lot of thrills."

McWicked and his now \$4,878,342 career bankroll show few signs of letting up.

Digging deep on rich International Trot history

The International Trot was contested at Roosevelt Raceway from 1959 to 1987.

Jamin won the first edition, and many remember the 'Artichoke' story associated with him generated by publicist Joey Goldstein. But many forget that two years later, Jamin, during the week of the third edition of the International, was lonely and was brought his own goat by Tina Louise, three years before she starred as Ginger on Gilligan's Island.

This year marked the 60th anniversary year of first era of the race and the 50th anniversary of Une De Mai defeating a pair of Horses of the Year in 1969 — Nevele Pride (1967-1968-1969 HOY) was second and Fresh Yankee (1970 HOY) was third. Une De Mai repeated as International champion in 1971 and when she was officially at Roosevelt in 1974 she was the richest of all standardbreds.

Ideal Du Gazeau won the Roosevelt International three straight years from 1981 to 1983, then was followed by Lutin D'Isigny back to back, giving France five straight International titles.

Of the 29 Internationals held at Roosevelt, the USA and France were tied with 11 victories each.

Su Mac Lad and Stanley Dancer became the first repeaters in the International, taking it in 1961 and 1963. Oddly, Su Mac Lad was the HOY in between International victories in 1962.

Peter Haughton won the last two Internationals he drove in — at age 23 and 24 in 1978 and 1979 with Cold Comfort and Doublemint, respectively.

Cold Comfort was to attempt a repeat in 1979, but a stall injury on the eve of the race necessitated his scratch.

The International used to be part of a three race package: The American Trotting Championship, Roosevelt International and Challenge Cup.

Armbro Flight was the 1965 Hambletonian runnerup and then the 1966 International winner. Delmonica Hanover and Savoir did the same. finishing second in the Hambletonian, then emerging victorious in the International. Savoir was the 1971 Hambletonian runnerup to Speedy Crown (the 1972 International winner) and then won the 1975 International. Delmonica Hanover was second to Super Bowl in 1972, then

backed up International wins in 1973-1974, the second one proving just enough to vault her to HOY honors despite just a 5-for-17 record.

The 1972 International winner, Speedy Crown, interrupted a streak of what could have been nine straight female winners. Speedy Crown, the sires of the richest female trotter, Moni Maker, is still the #1 trotting sire by progeny earnings of all time with over \$103 million made (Balanced Image at \$102 million is second).

Norway and Sweden won the last two Internationals at Roosevelt (1986 and 1987), respectively and then it moved to Yonkers in 1988 when Mack Lobell proved the best.

Fresh Yankee was a six-time Canadian representative in the Roosevelt International.

Roosevelt Raceway averaged 19,000 or more in attendance for 15 straight years from 1957-1971 and over 20,000 a night 11 straight seasons from 1957-1967.

Five times at Roosevelt a driver won the International back to back.

Herve Filion never captured the International.

The 1965 winner provided a nice payout for the longshot players. \$62.40 was the return for Pluvier III of Sweden before a crowd of 41,908.

Banner week for Björn Goop – 7,000th win and big victory in Finland

Swedish top driver and trainer Björn Goop celebrated his 7,000th victory in the bike when he won with Reverend Wine (Pastor Stephen) at Solvalla on Wednesday night (Oct. 9).

Goop passed his father Olle regarding most driving victories during 2018.

As a trainer, Björn Goop noted his 1,999th win on Friday night (Oct. 11) at Romme racetrack and among his biggest triumph as both trainer and driver he often mentions the Derby win with Conny Nobell (Pearsall Hanover) in 2005.

"I've driven many great horses and of course I have to count two victories in Elitloppet with Timoko and the Prix d'Amérique triumph with Readly Express as the most prestigious," Goop said after his 7,000th win at Solvalla.

Goop went east to Finland instead of racing in Sweden on Saturday afternoon when \$441,000 Grand Prix de l'U.E.T. for 4-year-olds was on the race card at Vermo racetrack in Helsinki. French dominant Face Time Bourbon (Ready Cash), trained by Sébastien Guarato, was Goop's weapon in the race and after a perfect trip in second over, the duo made an impressive move with a half mile to go in the 1.3 miles long race.

Face Time Bourbon disarmed leader Lewis Ale and kept his chasers behind him on his way home to a safe 1:53.4 mile rate win.

"This is a very quick horse and we got a nice trip, so I was satisfied during the race. I strongly suggest that the team around this horse aim for the Prix d'Amérique next year," said Goop, who earlier had won with Ecurie D. (Infinitif) in the \$132,000 European championship for 3-year-olds. Even this victory was taken in impressive style.

Ecurie D, trained by Frode Hamre, made an early break behind the gate and was seen several lengths behind the

field of six horses after the first quarter. With 5/8ths to go, Goop had found third over and the serious attack was made 500 meters from the wire. Ecurie D. followed leader Golden Dream M.E. throughout the last turn and Goop made his move mid-stretch. Ecurie D. fought to victory in mile rate 1:58.1 over 1.3 miles.

In the \$110,000 European Championship for 5-year-olds, first choice Villiam (Muscle Hill) had to do the heavy job outside leader Stonecapes Quelia (Otello Pierji) and the power was out when the field turned into the last turn. Stonecapes Quelia, driven by Hannu Torvinen, left his opponents with 200 meters to go and sprinted home in nice style in a mile rate 1:55.3.



has developed through the classes during 2019 and was one of the big surprises in the Elitloppet at Solvalla in May. The 5-year-old Ready Cash son finished fifth in the big mile race in Stockholm and trainer and driver Fredrik B Larsson has let his horse approach the very best trotters in Europe. When the SM was scheduled, he was one of the most interesting horses. But a post position in the second tier and a trip far back seemed to spoil all his chances to be a champion in Sweden.


Milliondollarrhyme's best attribute is his speed and after a last turn three wide, the Ready Cash son danced in the home stretch and took a four-length victory in moderate mile rate of 1:57.3.

"I'm shaking right now and that's not what I used to do after a race. We will aim for another try in Elitlloppet. It might be one more start this season, but then we'll make the horse ready for Elitloppet," said Larsson.

In the \$101,000 Swedish Championship for mares, Peter Untersteiner's Global Upper Style (S.J.'s Caviar) upset in a 85-1 victory for driver Ulf Ohlsson. The duo used the open stretch to capture leader Cash Crowe shortly ahead of the wire while first choice Mellby Free went off stride outside the leader in the last turn.

The mile rate for Global Upper Style was 1:56.2 over 1.3 miles.

Speaking of Propulsion, the champion trotter won the Masters final in Paris in September and whether he should continue on the trail of racing or not was not yet decided at that point, but earlier this week, Redén announced that he will give Propulsion the chance to capture more trophies in 2020, where the Elitloppet will be the biggest objective.



first four races on the program, but his biggest win of the night came with freshman trotter **TJ's Top Pick**. The Swan For All—J A's Ayd gelding entered the \$270,000 Super Final with seven wins in eight starts. He wrapped up divisional honors for trainer Jeff Cullipher with an easy 1:55.2 triumph. Tetrick never pulled the plugs on the 2-5 favorite as Swan In Motion and Dude Included followed in second and third, respectively.

"This has been a dream come true this year with this guy. Near perfection and he just does everything right," said Tom Pollack, who owns the freshman with Cullipher and Tetrick. "I think the more perfect he is the more nervous you get."

There was good reason to be nervous. The \$40,000 yearling purchase carried a nearly unblemished record into the final, as well as a target on his back. Drawing post eight, Tetrick wasted little time moving the favorite to the front and clicking off fractions of :28, :57.4 and 1:27.3 before swinging into the stretch a length in front of challenger Brigotto and Sam Widger. TJ's Top Pick cruised to a one and one-quarter length victory with Swan In Motion closing for second.

"It worked out like I thought. I wanted to go forward off the gate," Tetrick said in the winner's circle. "I was confident the whole way. I never even took the earplugs out."

Bred by Freeman Bontrager, TJ's Top Pick collected his eighth seasonal win and returned \$2.80-\$2.60-\$2.40. The victory raised his bankroll to \$302,871 and completed a sires stakes campaign where Cullipher worked to keep his star

pupil sound and at the top of his game.

"I can finally breathe; it's been a long year. We started from the day we got him, but once he got his speed we noticed we had a true horse," Cullipher said. "He's a good horse, and he makes my job easy. This win is probably the best."

Tetrick earned his first finals victory in the night's second race, deftly steering **Churita** to a 1:54.1 score over rival Hannelore Hanover in the \$70,000 event for older trotting mares. The 7-year-old Arizoom Lindy—Stonebridge Volare mare led gate-to-wire for trainer Matt Rheinheimer, and the victory pushed her over the \$1 million earnings mark. "She got to that million dollar mark the hard way," said Rheinheimer. "She's definitely one of a kind. She's got a great attitude and she's easy to take care of. She absolutely loves what she does."

Churita picked up her 43rd career win, coming in her 107th trip behind the starting gate. Her career earnings now stand at \$1,011,925. Hannelore Hanover, triple millionaire and former Horse of the Year, made her final Hoosier Park start for Burke Racing Stable.

The most exciting finish of the night came in the \$270,000 Super Final for freshman filly trotters. Slight favorite May Baby and James Yoder took control after a :27.1 opening quarter as second choice **Rock Swan** got away fourth for Tetrick before moving first up racing into the turn. In the stretch, Rock Swan looked to be an easy winner, but May Baby fought back valiantly before falling half a length short. The Erv Miller-trained Swan For All filly held on to earn her eighth win in 10 seasonal starts, tripping the timer in 1:57.2. Rjz First Lady rounded out the trifecta.

"Off the turn I thought she was a winner. In mid-stretch she got lost a little bit waiting for somebody," Tetrick said. "She's got a great attitude when it comes to wanting to win. She wants to beat everyone."

Bred by Bobby Brower and Deb Garland, Rock Swan is out of Indiana Sires Stakes champion Jolly Jessica. She is owned by S&R Racing Stables and Anthony Lombardi. With the win,

the filly raised her seasonal earnings to \$354,481.

Trained by Tyler George, who owns the mare in partnership with Samuel Schillaci and Wrenn Jr. Racing LLC, the victory was the 10th in 25 starts in 2019. older stallions and geldings by three and one-half lengths in a time of 1:53.1. Bred by Michael Wilt and Randy Wilt, the win was the 39th career victory for the trotter, owned by Bo De Long, Pat De Long, Ray De Long and Welch. The veteran has accumulated purse earnings of \$910,455.

In one of the most anticipated races of the night, **Tellmeaboutit** and Michael Oosting patiently waited along the rail before using the passing lane to capture the \$270,000 Super Final for sophomore pacing colts with a 1:50.3 performance. The Alvin Miller-trained Tellitlikeitis gelding finished two and one-half lengths in front as Melissa Essig's duo of Shamwow and Little Rocket Man finished second and third.

"We're just trying to bring him along and teach him to race," said Miller. "May of last year we had a pretty good idea of what he could actually do."

What Tellmeaboutit did Friday night was stake his claim to the division title by claiming his fifth seasonal win. When the gate folded, Oosting settled in third as Little Rocket Man and Tetrick set the fractions. They would not leave the pylons throughout the mile, waiting for the stretch to slip up the inside to secure the victory. Bred by Lavon Miller, the gelding has not finished off the board in 14 starts. Miller and 81-year-old Twila Harts, who was on hand to celebrate the win, own Tellmeaboutit.

The victory increased the sophomore's seasonal earnings to \$238,655. Career earnings now stand at \$324,055.

Silva Stables and Howard Taylor. Earning his sixth seasonal win and 15th career victory, the colt has accumulated \$390,563 this year, and his career bankroll is now \$645,743.

One year ago, **Grand Swan** entered the Super Final as the top freshman trotting filly, only to taste defeat. Friday night she was dominant in victory, pushing to the lead after three quarters for trainer and driver LeWayne Miller and drawing clear by nearly three lengths to take the \$270,000 final for three-year-old trotting fillies in 1:55 over a track rated sloppy. Victorious in seven of her previous 10 starts this year, the Swan For All—Queen Mum sophomore added her 16th career trip to the winner's circle in only 23 attempts. Bred by Larry Miller Jr., the filly is owned by Grand Swan Racing, Go Fast Stable and Never 2 Late Stable. Grand Swan has earned \$354,625 in 2019 and \$542,500 in two seasons of competition.

Priceless punched her ticket to the Breeders Crown Friday night on the strength of a 1:52.2 effort. Driven by trainer Brandon Bates, the Rockin Image lass led the \$270,000

Super Final for freshman filly pacers wire-to-wire, finishing six and one-half lengths ahead of the field to add her sixth win in nine starts. Foxy Rigger and Grace Rocks managed to finish second and third.

"She is just game, loves to win, and loves to race," said Bates. "We'll load up Wednesday and head to Mohawk, give it a try in the Breeders Crown elimination."

Bred by Mark Graber, Mervin Graber and Jacob Graber, Priceless was purchased by Bert Hochsprung and Kevin Miller out of the Hoosier Classic sale for \$31,000. With tonight's win, the filly has earned \$328,662.

the last turn and went on to score a 1:53 victory in the \$270,000 final for freshman pacing colts for driver Peter Wrenn. The favorite finished two lengths better than Always And Again while Clever Character held on for third. Melanie Wrenn conditions the Rockin Image gelding owned by Odds On Racing.

"The colt's a little green on the lead. I thought there would be more mixup in the first quarter, but he felt good tonight. When I got ahead with him, he felt nice," Wrenn said.

The \$60,000 yearling purchase, bred by Merlie Schwartz, added his sixth win in seven starts. Odds On Osiris has earned \$313,145 and returned \$3.40-\$2.40-\$2.10.

Rockin Nola, 2-year-old divisional champion in Indiana in 2018, collected her second Super Final victory Friday night with a 1:51.4 score. Driven by Joey Putnam, the Rockin Image sophomore used her late kick to propel to a two-length victory as second choice in the \$270,000 event for pacing fillies. Favored Fully A Virgin settled for second and Lady Capulet raced third.

Drawing post three for trainer Joe Putnam, Rockin Nola raced ninth early as Play For Pay reached the quarter in :26.3. Pansy's Image would brush to the lead on the backstretch as Rockin Nola joined the outer flow third over. The filly advanced to third at the top of the stretch and dashed home in :26.3 to secure her sixth win of the year.

"The trip worked out like I thought. I wanted to get away sixth or seventh and wanted a good runway to get out," Putnam said. "Winning with a filly like this is huge. It can't get any better than this."

Owned by the trainer in partnership with Suttons Bay Racing and Novi Trot LLC, Rockin Nola pushed her 2019 earnings to \$238,822. Bred by Mahlon Lambright, the filly has banked \$398,922 over the last two seasons.

Cullipher and Pollack teamed for their second Indiana Sires Stakes final in the \$50,000 contest for older stallion and gelding pacers. **Incredible Shark**, sent off at odds of 13-1, sprinted home in :27.4 to finish a quarter-length in front of Rockin Speed in a time of 1:51. Sam Widger guided the Shadyshark Hanover five year old to his fifth win of the year and second in his last four starts. Tookadiveoffdipper paced third for John De Long.

Bred by Hoosier Standardbred Farm and Fair Meadow Farm, Incredible Shark returned \$27.40-\$11.20-\$5.40 to his backers. The gelding improved his 2019 earnings to \$105,674. He now possesses a career bankroll of \$332,499.

Part two: involve bettors to participate in all events with rewards to increase business

In the realm of "all harness racing is local," we continue with our suggestions from part one on involving bettors in driving championships races (part one here).

Here are the essentials to the plan, which may be used as a template for other such events (to be addressed in part three).

Call the promotion something like "Driving Partners" or "Drive Time Play" — anything that sounds catchy. The shorter the name, the better it sticks in the minds of bettors.

First and foremost, tell bettors they could win "VALUABLE BETTING VOUCHERS" by participating. Exactly how many vouchers are rewarded is up to the track, but it is imperative there is not going to be a single winner, that is, prizes will be awarded in tiers. (More people will have the initiative to when it costs nothing and you can still win something.)

An example of prizes:

The person or person(s) backing the championship's winning driver will receive \$100 in betting vouchers each (for your track only — you may add any other conditions you deem necessary). Second-placers in points win \$50 in vouchers each; third-placers in points win \$20 in vouchers; and fourth-placers in points win \$5 in vouchers. Note that if for any reason no one committed to the driver that wins, all participants will receive a prize that the track decides upon (one of your promotional items already in stock).

Here are some suggested rules:

Before the designated contest races begin, a bettor must record his or her commitment to supporting a driver to win the entire contest (more than one person can commit to the same driver). Bettors record their allegiance to one driver by filling in a short form on the track website or at some designated spot at the track itself. (Always ask — do not require — that a contest participant add their email address to allow future announcements and promotions to be delivered).

Contest participants are encouraged — not required — to wager on their driver choice when he or she is in one of the championship racing legs.

Someone in the racing office, let's say, maintains the simple calculations (keeping score of points for participants) as they ensue.

The publicity director will set up a "Leader Board."

Here is one concept for using a driver championship for the bettors signed up for it:

Encouragement to wager on the races is presented by the track announcer, who adds to his or her script for a designated race something like: "This race is a leg in the [Driving Partners] contest, so if you signed up to back a driver, you may want to make some money yourself by supporting him (or her) in this race."

You get the idea.

A very simple point system is developed for participants. An example:

Bettors whose driver wins a leg get 10 points; a place finish awards 5 points; a show finish awards 3 points and finishing fourth awards 1 point.

The person in charge of keeping tabs of points records what is earned by bettors from the contestants' original commitments, and as the contest ensues; the Leader Board, an ongoing report on the standings, is posted on the track website (pump it up on the home page each time there is a change) and one or two spots at the track.

At the end of the contest, when the winning driver is announced, also announce the winning bettor(s). Any and all of them showing up at the track the night of the announcements will be invited into the winner's circle to take photos with the championship driver.

It should not end there.

Afterwards, have your PR person interview the winning driver in a brief video (it is so easy these days to visually record such moments) and the top winner(s) of his or her supporters in the contest. Post those videos on your website and if you have a YouTube page, post them there, too.

No one loses; not even the extras that wound up with drivers that did not earn enough points to reward a voucher. After all, it cost nothing to sign up.

An important angle to this connection is appealing to the bettor as an informed, respected member of the wagering community. When you allow the bettor to make his or her own decision on how to gamble, you are sending a message of trust, saying, "Hey, we know you are making calculated risks (betting) based on your knowledge of the game." This is why one rule has to apply to all of the public-involved events you produce.

Never assign bettors a choice by lottery.

As we always emphasize in this department, understanding the nature of your customer is essential to keeping your customer satisfied, loyal and appreciated. It is not so difficult, and yet the racetrack industry has continued to keep its distance from the very people that support its existence.

See you later, girls: Courageous Lady to Skater Chick

With exactly one race for horses and geldings on the 14-race card, Saturday night was definitely ladies' night at Northfield Park. The \$120,500 Courageous Lady headlined the evening, attracting seven 3-year-old distaff pacers to Ohio's half-mile "Home of the Flying Turns."

Morning line favourite #5 Jk American Beauty (p, 3, 1:51.0m; \$323,648 before October 12) recorded her last victory Sept. 21 at Freehold Raceway, when she wired the four-filly Homegrown field in 1:54.2h. The Nancy Johansson-trained daughter of American Ideal—Jk Black Beauty (Bettors Delight) was making her debut for new catch driver Brett Miller, in pursuit of her fourth win in 15 seasonal tries.

Early second choice #3 So Awesome (p, 2, 1:53.3h; \$446,113 before October 12) also came into the Courageous Lady with four 2019 victories. The Scott DiDomenico trainee was teamed up with Dave Palone for the first time in the Grand Circuit filly stake.

But it was #2 **Skater Chick** (p, 3, 1:50.3s; \$95,504 before October 12) who said "see you later" and rewarded her backers and driver Corey Callahan with the Courageous Lady win.

So Awesome went to the early lead and reached the opening quarter in L27.4, followed by a single-file #1 Shes Allright (Ronnie Wrenn Jr.), Skater Chick, and Jk American Beauty. As the field rounded the second turn, Palone's filly sustained her lead to the 57 flat half, but soon saw pressure coming overland in the form of the first-over Skater Chick, who was followed second-over by Jk American Beauty. By the 1:25.1 three-quarters, announcer Ayers Ratliff declared So Awesome and the oncoming Skater Chick "on even terms", with an eager Jk American Beauty seemingly poised to tip three-wide behind the sparring leaders. As So Awesome gave way and backed down, Skater Chick accelerated to the wire in a final time of 1:53.1, with Jk American Beauty just over two lengths back in second. The sole Ohio-bred in the field, #7 Rose Run Uptowngal (Chris Page), closed to complete the triactor.

Skater Chick (Sweet Lou-Ram Rocker, by Rocknroll Hanover) had finished third for Callahan and trainer Mark Harder in her prior start, a \$30,000 division of the John Simpson Memorial Oct. 2 at Harrah's Philadelphia. Bred by Diamond Creek Farm and purchased for \$25,000 at the 2017 Lexington yearling sale, the 2019 Courageous Lady champ is owned by Donald Lindsey of Fergus, ON; Paul W. Kleinpaste of Orangeville, ON; and Garth S. Bechtel of Caledon East, ON.



Skater Chick provided her reinsman with a major win on his first night driving at Northfield. Callahan told interviewer Dave Bianconi, "You know, with scheduling conflicts, I just didn't have the right horse to come for it" previously, but he was familiar with Skater Chick and liked her chances. "Mark (Harder) had her last year as a 2-year-old," said Callahan, who knew the filly's style well enough to pilot her to the victory. "If you look at her last few lines, at The Meadows, Tony Hall drove her and she was first up both times" in a pair of place finishes. Skater Chick recently returned to Harder's barn after an Ontario sojourn with conditioner Donald Lindsey earlier this year.

"She does get a little rough in the turns some," said Callahan, who nonetheless enjoyed a smooth ride behind the 2-1 winner. He told Bianconi he hoped to return with another filly in 2020: "We've got to defend the title next year, right?"

The Courageous Lady Pace, formerly known as the "Lady Catskill", moved from Monticello Raceway to Northfield Park in 1990. It was renamed in honor of the Ohio-sired champion Courageous Lady (p,3,T1:54.4; \$418,256), whose owner Ruth Cohen outlived her terminal cancer prognosis by several years as she followed her filly's racing career.

On the undercard, Mary Birkhold gave #5 **Bestinthebusiness** his second victory of the year in the first of two Pace for the Cure events. The 11-year-old gelding successfully chased down tiring leader #3 Fusion Five (Rachel Kaneoka) in the stretch. "(Trainer) Brett (Boyd) told me the horse could leave and I said, 'Well, let's see how it goes," Birkhold told Dave Bianconi. "It makes it an extra-special win, because it's a breast cancer race."

In race 8, the second Pace for the Cure race, #5 **Clouseau Hanover** (Madison Cullipher) fended off a first-over #2 Blue Spanx (Jayme Weller) for the 1:56.1 victory. However, an inquiry against the unofficial winner resulted in a placing: Blue Spanx was moved up to first, and Clouseau Hanover set back to third for obstructing the passing lane. Despite a scratch in each of the two races, 17 female drivers took part in the 2019 Northfield Pace for the Cure, a fundraising promotional night in support of the American Cancer Society.

He must have noticed he was the center of attention, so he turned the tables by asking, "You mentioned that you didn't buy a yearling this year."

"Nope"

"Why not?"


"Cash flow issues. You may be a billionaire, I'm a nillionaire, big difference."

"You didn't even go window shopping?"

"Nah, going to yearling sales is a blast, but I'm like Oscar Wilde, I can resist anything but temptation."

He smiled and asked, "What about the yearling colt that you have on the breeding farm, the one from your broodmare? Did the colt sell strong, did you get your price, and did you go to the sale to watch him sell?"

"Nope, nope and nope. We didn't consign him, so that colt remains in limbo. I'm in the middle of another effort to reinvent the wheel. This time I will tackle the world of



yearling marketing, innovation by mortification. It's what I do."

He leaned back, smiled, and said, "Here we go, another Trey train is about to leave the station."

I rolled on, "For years, the normal MO for my pal and me was going to a sale and coming home with one yearling. We did this happy dance many times as buyers, but lately, we have been sellers."

"So."

"Buying and selling are different worlds; there is a lot of pressure in both camps. As buyers you have your list of possible candidates, you run around like a lunatic picking up feet and pretending you know what you are doing, counting down until the ones you want to bid on hit the stage. Your only tools are the pedigree page and the horse. It's kind of scary and I wanna fix that."

"Fix what?"

"Information flow, it's limited."

He asked, "It's an unknown yearling, what's to know that isn't on the page?"

"Lots of things. For example, every yearling we have bought was raised on a big farm like Hanover or Hickory Lane. We never bought a yearling from a small farm or a mom and pop operation."

"Why not?"

"Lots of reasons, some legit, some not. Plenty of

homegrown yearlings intrigued us but we never knew if the horse was raised alone in a garage in Sheboygan. In addition, we always asked ourselves, 'If this horse is so great, why are they selling?' Big farms have to sell, unknown farms are... well. unknown."

He asked, "Is this going to be a typical Trey grievance of corporations crushing local businesses?"

"It happens. We have sent six little piggies to market. They really were not piggies because they all raced fine and made money, but we brought half of them home because we did not get what we believed was the fair market value at the sale."

He shook a finger, "Actually, as a little guy, you held an advantage over the commercial farms. You had the option of bringing them home to race."

"True, but the unknown scares buyers. If customers know the people selling the yearling have the option of racing, they are probably leery when the horse takes the stage at an auction."

"So what's your angle?"

"It's your kind of angle, Mister Silicon Valley. This plan is total techie, gig economy, social networking, links, and all that crapola. Trey will try his own little internet IPO startup initiative. I think I am going to brand it, 'The Inside Story.'"

He gave a little clap, "Do tell."

I clasped my hands below my chin and spoke like Gandhi, "My dear friend, every person is a story. Every horse is a story. Every yearling is a short story. Essentially, my latest plan is to tell that story more completely than has ever told before."

He opened his palms and then said, "That's stupid, even I know those customers have bought, those sales are over, and they will be out of money."

But I wanted to see how the first crops of our mare and her sister raced. First foal performance is important information. I will probably make my move on Sunday, October 27."

"I'm going tell the complete story of this yearling colt, answer all questions. I will use videos, graphs, links, and stuff I have yet to think of. Dude, this will be revolutionary. No more relying on just a pedigree, a souped-up video and a panicky two minutes under the lights."

He gave an encouraging nod of his head, "One advantage I see is that you have more control."

I nodded, "And it will give the buyer a more complete backstory."

"Your idea's still a bit fuzzy. Why don't you make a prototype, show me exactly what you have in mind, and maybe I can tweak it before the big reveal."

I gave him a thumbs up, "I'm on the case." I then turned my thumb into a circling index finger, "Barkeep, tab please."

George Napolitano, Jr. earns 10,000th driving win

George Napolitano, Jr. became the 18th North American driver to tally 10,000 driving victories on Saturday night (Oct. 12) at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono when he guided Motown N to a hard-earned victory in the evening's ninth race.

Motown N tucked third early, then used one of Napolitano's signature moves, a brush off the first turn, to make his way to the lead, but not until being parked the entire second quarter. Once on top, Motown N and Napolitano were in control, with "George Nap" rocking the horse home to a two-length victory over Redbank Blaze A – driven by George's brother Anthony.

Motown N did not recognize the milestone achieved by his driver, as he was under full steam right back to the paddock after the mile. But George was brought to the winner's circle after "dropping off" the horse to join family, friends, and Pocono management to celebrate the major achievement.

George Napolitano Jr. currently ranks 11th among active North American drivers in victories, and he is well on his way to taking his 13th seasonal crown at The Downs, and his eighth straight. George also has ten UDR titles at Pocono, and he was the winningest trainer here in five seasons. The win behind Motown N was his 4,982nd victory at Pocono since his first victory success in 2000. George won the North American dash-winning title in 2010, and this year he currently sits third in the standings.

Captain Barbossa and Papi Rob Hanover won in impressive fashion in Kindergarten Classic action Friday night as live racing returned to the Meadowlands after a nine-week hiatus.

A son of Captaintreacherous—Swinging Beauty, Captain Barbossa was an easy three-quarter length, wire-to-wire

winner over Team Best in the first of two dashes for colts and geldings on the pace in the Kindergarten, which is for 2-year-olds.

Andy McCarthy put the Tony Alagna trainee on the point early, then cut out all the fractions on the way to a 1:52 score, his third win in 12 lifetime starts. The lifetime earner of \$113,079, who returned \$2.60 to his backers as the 1-5 public choice, has hit the board nine times.

In the other division for male pacers, 1-9 favorite Papi Rob Hanover was a dominant winner for driver David Miller and trainer Brett Pelling as the son of

Somebeachsomewhere—Panera Hanover stopped the clock in 1:52.

Miller had the lifetime earner of \$315,358 sit a three-hole trip to the top of the stretch before swinging wide in the lane and easily powering past his foes to record a 2½-length score over Force N Fury. He's won three-of-eight in his career, hitting the board in every start, and returned \$2.10 to win.

Purse increase for Garden State Trot

The Standardbred Breeders and Owners Association of New Jersey (SBOANJ) has announced that there will be a significant purse increase to both the Garden State Trot #1 and the Garden State Trot #2 based on the addition of the state-sired appropriation funding.

The Garden State Trot #1 for 3-year-old New Jersey Sired trotters scheduled to race at Freehold Raceway, fillies Friday, Oct. 25 and colts Saturday, Oct. 26, was previously advertised with an estimated purse of \$50,000. The new minimum purse has been increased to \$80,000 for both fillies and colts.

The Meadowlands will play host to the Garden State Trot #2 for 2-year-old New Jersey Sired trotters. It was advertised as a \$60,000 purse, which will be increased to a minimum purse of \$90,000 for both fillies and colts to be raced on Nov. 9.

After reading Joe Thomson's salient observation about the effects of Heads of State on yearling prices (full story here), and noticing that five of the top 10 prices at Fasig Tipton were due to either Canadian or Swedish bidding, I think we would be remiss not to give a nice shout out to Justin Trudeau and Stefan Löfven.

Shouldn't on-air handicappers bet the tickets they tout?

I started a wonderful discussion on Twitter, when an on air handicapper revealed to me he does not actually put his money on his suggestions. I found that odd. If you are suggesting listeners play from \$72-\$360 on a Pick 5 shouldn't you at least bet a 20 cent ticket? Some of the big names in harness racing freely admitted they do bet on their suggestions on these exotics. At least, the fact should be clearly stated that the on air announcer is not betting his suggestion. It's a lot easier to whack the ALL button on a "make believe" ticket then a real one. In reality, I find it doubtful that a big bettor models his exotics on what an on air announcer thinks. And a regular bettor rarely bets over \$10 on an exotic wager. Most bettors would go broke early by risking large amounts in the first race pick 5.

Is International purse better served elsewhere?

I totally commend the effort in putting together an international field of trotters that went for \$1 million. Congratulations to Italy for winning impressively. That being said, if you were given \$1 million to promote, advance or support our sport is that where you would have spent it? I do not object that a race of this size is a well-kept secret outside our industry. My main concern is that any money won by Europeans is basically taken out of the North American racing economy. This is very different than when horses are purchased from other countries. In those cases, we are getting goods for our money. I know it sounds very selfish and self-serving to air this analysis. But our industry needs all of economic stimulus it can get. It is not just the million dollars, less whatever is won and remains in North America. It is the velocity of money that would get spent many times and have a multiplying affect domestically. The result is essentially the same as when there is a dispersal, as one that is about to happen in Harrisburg with White Birch Farm, where the proceeds are removed forever.

Again, I commend the intentions and effort involved in putting on this event successfully, but I would have rather seen those funds put into the overnight purse account or any other type of invitationals or stake races so that those funds would be recycled in our industry over and over again.


