Meadowlands in mourning

The death of Dave Brower is just another immeasurable tragedy in The Big M family.

A week ago, The Meadowlands family was once again rocked to its core.

The news that Dave Brower, 53, was found unresponsive in his Lexington hotel room Friday morning (Oct. 7) a little over five years after Sam McKee, 54, died from stroke complications, was almost too much to bear.

In both cases it was the kind of news that makes you wish you were dreaming so you could wake up and it wouldn't be true.

Unlike McKee, who had been in the hospital following the aforementioned stroke, Brower showed no major signs of what was to come.

The outpouring of love on social media, since the confirmation of Brower's passing, has been overwhelming.

Driver Dave Glasser was on his way to compete in the Billings Amateur Series at Vernon Downs when he heard the news about Brower passing earlier that day. As soon as he could, Glasser found a store where he could buy material that he fashioned into black armbands worn by every driver in that race, which was introduced as the "Dave Brower Memorial."

That same night, prior to the Monmouth at The Meadowlands thoroughbred races, Big M chief operating officer/general manager Jason Settlemoir paid tribute to Brower, saying in part:

"Dave was a great friend and a great employee. Dave will be missed by not only by The Meadowlands Racetrack but the entire horse racing community.



Harness Racing Update

A Celebration of Life ceremony for Brower will be held at The Meadowlands on Saturday, Nov. 12 prior to the races.

It's never easy to lose someone you care about, but when it comes so unexpectedly and to someone still in the prime of their life, it's much harder to comprehend.

My husband, Dave Little, and I, knew Brower for over 30 years and I was fortunate enough to work with him in 1996. It was Brower's first year doing Meadowlands' TV and my husband and I were featured on the show as the handicapping combo known as the "Dueling Littles."

We were good friends over the years, but never more so than in the last five years when Brower and my husband became on-air partners on The Meadowlands show.

I interviewed Brower many times for my column and he was always proud of the job that the TV department did at the mecca of harness racing.

"People forget sometimes that it's live TV," said Brower. "You only have one chance to get it right and when it comes down to it, we do. Our TV staff on both sides of the cameras are professionals and I couldn't be prouder of what we are able to accomplish."

Over time, many have posted that there was unbeatable chemistry on the "Dave and Dave" show. But what made it so good?

"Knowing the strengths of the man in the other chair," said Little. "In my opinion, he was better as a co-host, because he had such a wide scope of knowledge."

I once asked Brower about their chemistry specifically when it came to a complicated night like the 2021 live Meadowlands Pace show. Until now I have never shared this quote with anyone, including my husband.

"If you ever tell him this, I might deny it," said Brower with a laugh. "I never have to worry when he's sitting next to me. No matter what is happening, however crazy it is, when I stop talking, I know he will start and keep going."

"I can't tell you how much time we had to fill with the shoe repair and the inquiry but it felt like forever. And every time I threw to Dave he just kept talking. I don't know how he had so much to say, but he did and that's what makes him good and what makes us good."

The love and respect that the Daves had for each other was apparent to anyone who watched that show and it's hard to imagine how difficult it will be for Little to go back to that set when The Meadowlands opens on Nov. 4, knowing Brower will never sit next to him again.

One thing I do know is that someone will eventually sit in Brower's vacant seat, but no one will ever take his place.

The incalculable loss of Dave Brower

Devastating.

Unbelievable.

Unbearable.

That's for starters.

The sudden passing of Dave Brower on the morning of Oct. 7 was deeply shocking.

I think of all the people in racing I might have known Brower the longest. Right around 1986-1987 there was a young man hanging around the press box at the Meadowlands, His presence would become more frequent the following year or so. You know the term gym rat? Dave was the very first "press box pest."

Years later, when reminded of that he smiled and readily agreed. You see, he always loved the sport. Now, as an over-eager teen, he was priming himself to do something about it.

I was there when some decisions like "let that young kid do it" or "He won't mind" were made by writers or management — circa 1989/1990 or so. Brower was the happiest guy on earth doing anything associated with racing. That's because he knew thoroughbreds, too, and he worked at a track that occasionally played host to both breeds.

The standardbred sport invited Brower to join the table and he quickly sat down. I'm not sure in the past three decades plus I know of a better fit. He became in the last 20 years or so a 24/7 walking advertisement for the sport. Big events — Brower was right there. And if he was not working the gig, he was schmoozing with someone somewhere. If harness racing was a Democratic Convention, he would have won the nomination on the first ballot.

Friend **Anthony Francesco, III** said, "We lost a great person when God called Dave last week. I've known Dave many years and we would text opinions on horses back and forth. The way horses raced and whether or not to follow them next week. He loved the game. On Jug day, he gave me a shout-out on live feed and

I'm a nobody. To him I was somebody and he made my day. It's amazing how just minutes after this happened social media became 'Brower media.' Everyone posting their condolences. Even Bulldog's race wasn't the same. I know we all need to go on but we should all keep Dave in our conversations as if he was still here. He won't be replaced because they don't make them like him anymore."

In the early 1990s with the popularity of the TV show Doogie Howser, Brower was also given that nickname Doogie by Moira Fanning. I am 99 per cent sure of that. The name was not original, but Brower was. One of the first jobs he held was with *Sports Eye* charting races. He was Charlie Singer-like in his ability to see pretty much everything in the race the first time. It was also about this time that Brower was revealed as a bonafide foodie — long before anyone had even heard that term.

Michelle Egli said, "He was a great guy and I'll miss him. Harness racing won't be the same. He was a giving devoted friend, cat lover, a foodie and a damned good cook."

Brower's dad passed in 1992. They both had already made many friends in the industry by then. Brower made his way onto TV semi-regularly not too long after that. Program selections too. Simulcasting was coming into clearer focus around then. The saying "Live TV" would now be heard regularly around the TV crew and press box. Almost everything prior was on tape. In 1998-2001, The "INSIDE TRACK" began and I think Brower's visibility was now commonplace. He was a big part of show which was 30 minutes per week of pretty much every big race. That was not easy to do. Brower was just as comfortable on the apron as he was on the TV set. No adjustments needed. What you always saw was what you got.

Mark Weaver said, "Still hard to process. He was a mainstay on so many of the sports' biggest days. He will be missed!"

Sarah Lauren and Howard Perlmutter said, "He was simply selfless in the booth. He would be odds-on to give a shout-out to any individual — high profile or not — to those who made any contribution to the sport. It was his life's passion to bring harness racing to the forefront. Other social interactions came second."

Steve Katz said, "As a fellow native of Passaic County, I always took pride in Dave's accomplishments. He truly loved the sport and its people-and of course, our horses. In a way he filled a similar role — especially on social media — to Del Miller as harness racing's 'Goodwill Ambassador."


Joel Kahan, a 20-year regular right next to the TV set said, "Dave Brower was the best TV host in the business. He was a natural for TV. He loved harness racing and was a top ambassador for the sport. A great guy and everyone's friend. I will miss seeing him on TV and when I go back to the Meadowlands. 'Brower power' was one of my lines."

In 2010, for the very first time, the Breeders Crown went to a one-site, one-night format at Pocono. I did the entire show with Brower. From sunlight at 5 in the afternoon to frostbite at midnight. Not a complaint from Brower, though. This was where he had always dreamed of being.

Brower always had a "reset" button nearby — and he wasn't even married.

You see, we all get out of hand at times. We all are hard to deal with on occasion — me included, most certainly. Brower had an uncanny sense of this. There could be chaos everywhere but soon order was restored. A certain air of calm that served him — and us — well.

John Kopas never even met Brower, but said, "Just watching him on the many broadcasts he was on I knew he was a great asset to the business. We have lost a shining star."

Peter Blood also never met Brower, but said, "I did know his work. His passing will leave a monumental void in the broadcasting of our sport."

Bruce Riegle lives in Kentucky and appreciated Brower's input. Riegel said, "He was the King of the Red Mile. All sorts of people knew him. When he went on air he had his news and current events updated."

Paul Kelley recognized the fan in Brower. Kelley said, "We all know what a true fan of the game Dave was but more importantly he was a kind person. That's what is most important in life."

Matt McDowell is a field service technician, Brower's besties did not have to be in the biz. McDowell said, "First time I met him was in the Meadowlands paddock. I was fairly new. He showed me around from there and it was an instant friendship. Then the next year he and some friends were at the Red Mile. We all met up for dinner and I showed my buddies all around Lexington. Anytime we would see each other we would sit and talk and catch up. A great friend and would do anything for anyone."

James Witherite said, "Dave was one of the best, if not THE best, goodwill ambassador racing ever had. In my 16 years working the sport, I've always known Dave to be someone who encouraged, included and made the people around him better. He was the consummate pro — always knowing how to amplify the stories of the horses, horsepeople and horseplayers while never injecting himself into the plot. Always accessible to the

fans and participants and genuinely willing to engage when off the set. We're all richer for having known the man."

Carter Pinske is about half Brower's' age. Of course, that made no difference to Brower. Carter said, "Dave was very professional and a true fan of the sport. Like Sam McKee, when you think of big races or the Meadowlands, It's the voice you hear. Hard to replace."

Sam McKee – gone in 2017 at 54. Brower was 53. McKee's last weekend ever at the Red Mile was the 1:46 flat from Always B Miki in 2016. Brower's last weekend included his picks in the program right up to Sunday. When 1:46 was reached again – this time by Allywag Hanover.

McKee and Brower had been a tandem since 1999 when McKee officially made the move from Michigan to the Meadowlands.. Let me relate what **McKee's wife Chris** had to say, "In Sam's own words, 'The guy was a class act. He was always professional and could read the room — never needing to be scripted and seemingly pulling from his deep knowledge of harness racing.' Brower could always fill the gaps where Sam lacked — reaching the fan base on a personal level via social media. Dave was pure on-air talent."

Bob McClure said, "An absolute gift to our industry for many years. A complete gentleman that I'm not sure ever had a bad day."

Dave Palone said, "Dave absolutely loved what he did for a living and he was very good at it. Complete gut punch for all of us. So sorry for his family."

Travis Alexander said, "Dave was the rare individual who always was the same person on or off the camera. Friend of mine — friend of the business. He will be greatly missed."

PJ Fraley took care of Mr Muscleman (2002-2008 or so), but he and Brower were buds even prior to that. Fraley said, "From the backside to the press box Dave was always a true gentleman — more like a good friend. Whether it would be sitting having a cold beer and barbeque talking about horses or just asking how life was. I often would make it a point to stop up to the booth and say Hi. With a big smile he would greet me and ask me if I liked anything and then tell, 'PJ, I can never get anything out of you.' He will be truly missed and his legacy will live on forever."

Sometimes in life we all fall guilty to expecting too much — especially continuity. Your favorite TV series has been great for the first two seasons — of course there'll be a third. Three decades the same favorite deli — No need to change now. Your hometown team just won five in a row — Why not 6-7-8?

But, what do we do when the continuity is tragically disrupted? Gather together, for sure. Unify. We are reminded of the frailty of life and to live every single day. Hold your loved ones closer.

The Kentucky Futurity - Bulldog Hanover weekend was the one where we lost Brower. You can be sure he did not want to be the story — ever. These are the weekends and events he lived for. Brower lived his life his own way. How many of us can say we were crazed teenage fans who then launched a successfully career in that very business?

The next weeks, months and years will offer constant reminders of Dave Brower. Obvious ones and small potatoes, too.


He was far too young for anyone to forget. Yet, he packed a ton into that bio. We'll miss a lot from Dave Brower.

Bulldog Hanover finally lost. Now what?

In one of the most anticipated races ever from the historic Red Mile oval, it was Allywag Hanover who played the role of spoiler when he parlayed a dreamy, trouble-free trip into a one-anda-half length win in 1:46 over Bulldog Hanover in last week's Allerage Farms open pace. For Bulldog Hanover, the loss put an end to what should come to be simply known in harness racing circles as "the streak," in which he strung together the best 11-race win streak ever seen in the history of the sport. Now, likely with just two races left in his 4-year-old season and his career, how should Bulldog Hanover be evaluated?

Looking first at last week's Allerage Farms pace, driver Dexter Dunn was quoted post-race that Bulldog Hanover "raced great," but that "he maybe wasn't quite as sharp." It may not seem like it on the surface, but timewise, Bulldog Hanover's defeat could be considered just as good as almost any other race he's had this year.

In a race where Dunn may have taken a different approach if the emphasis was solely on beating his equine opponents rather than racing against the clock, Bulldog Hanover was timed in 1:46.1. That clocking was accomplished on the final day of the Grand Circuit meet at the Red Mile, where the track had been playing relatively meek over the two weeks by speed standards, and that was no exception on Sunday.

But still, the race time of 1:46 tied the all-time track record and was superior to any other race on that day. The next fastest race that day on the trot-heavy card was the Tattersalls Pace, and that time of 1:48.3 by Pebble Beach was over two and a half seconds slower than the Allerage Farms open. Similarly, Niki Hill was the only other sub-1:50 win on the card when she won the Glen Garnsey Memorial in 1:48.4.

Perhaps the best point of reference was Test Of Faith's win that day in the Allerage Farms fillies and mares open in 1:50.1. Bulldog Hanover was 20 lengths better than her on Sunday, comparing the times to each other. But when Bulldog Hanover set his 1:45.4 world record on July 16 at the Meadowlands, Test Of Faith went in 1:47 the very race prior; just six lengths slower than Bulldog Hanover. The point being, it's not like Allywag Hanover and Bulldog Hanover paced in tandem to another near-record mile on a day when records were being set all over such as almost any race card from the Meadowlands this summer; they far exceeded relative to other performances that same day.

With all that said, Sunday's race likely didn't change how you feel about Bulldog Hanover. If you thought he was the best horse ever going into that race, you probably still feel the same. If you were skeptical of taking his greatness to that level, you probably feel somewhat validated. What's for near certainty though, is that no matter how Bulldog Hanover's final two races go, we've seen the greatest season by a 4-year-old, ever.

The closest winning streak I can think of by an older horse that mirror's what Bulldog Hanover has accomplished is what Sweet Lou did back in 2014, though he did it as a 5-year-old. That year, Sweet Lou put together a 10-race win streak that at one point included six consecutive winning times of 1:47.4, 1:47, 1:47.1, 1:47.3, 1:47.2, 1:47.2.

Similarly, Always B Miki compiled a record-setting string of performances including separate smaller winning streaks en route to a Hall of Fame resume in 2016, but he too did it as a 5-year-old. In winning 12 of 18 races that year, he not only set the then all-time world record of 1:46, but he also paced multiple 1:47 miles over five-eighths mile tracks in winning the Ben Franklin at Pocono and the Jim Ewart Memorial at Scioto. It seems like a race that doesn't get as much attention as it should, but that win in the Ewart when he battled first-over against Wiggle It Jiggleit should be considered one of the best races of all-time.

You could continue through the lists and find plenty of noteworthy seasons by the FFA pacing stars through the years, but what Bulldog Hanover has done as a 4-year-old against predominantly older horses is unprecedented, and it's not even close. Where the debate will continue on is how Bulldog Hanover will eventually be viewed as an all-time great, or perhaps even the all-time great.

In part, how Bulldog Hanover closes out the year in the Breeders Crown and in the TVG Pace will be part of that determination. In a way, losing to Allywag Hanover in the Allerage Farms still may work out towards Bulldog Hanover's benefit if he can avenge that defeat. If there is any knock to Bulldog Hanover – and this isn't any fault of his own – it's that he hasn't been up against the strongest group of FFA pacers ever seen this year. A solid group for sure, but the defending Dan Patch winner of this division, Allywag Hanover hadn't been eligible for stakes throughout much of the year and perhaps things could have turned out a bit different had he been. Those two appear slated to meet up again in the Breeders Crown at Woodbine Mohawk Park, home turf for Bulldog Hanover. It's possible they could meet once more to close out the year in the TVG open pace at the Meadowlands if Allywag Hanover were to win the Breeders Crown.

It's fun to speculate where this year will put Bulldog Hanover in the harness racing annals, but nothing can take away the fact that he's unquestionably produced one of the most memorable single seasons ever seen. Let's see if he can finish what he's started by closing out the year and his career with two more wins in races that will not be easy, and at that point he'll have a completed body of work with which to assess.

Twenty years in, the obsession with standardbreds hasn't faded for Ashley Dowis

It's certainly no stretch to say Ashley Dowis is married to her job.

Just after she had graduated high school in her native Ohio almost 20 years ago, the then teenager embarked on a career search, looking to find a full-time gig in the Buckeye State.

Before she landed an interview, a relative came to her with a suggestion, one that gave her pause for thought.

"My cousin is [veteran standardbred trainer] Ron Potter. When I was finished high school, he actually called me when I was out job hunting and he said, 'Hey, do you want to groom for some horses for me?' I thought I'd try it out, so I did that, and I've never left."

Eighteen years later, Dowis has zero regrets over the decision she made to become a harness racing caretaker.

In fact, there is nothing else, she offered, that could lure her away from the sport.

"I was addicted right away," she said with a laugh. "I was a riding-horse girl. I showed Western Pleasure and I barrel raced, but I sold my riding horses almost immediately when I started with the standardbreds. I absolutely love these animals. They really are amazing."

It didn't take long for Dowis to develop a bond with the horses she was tasked with looking after.

Days into her racing life, there was nowhere else she wanted to be.

"These horses, they are so versatile. And they appreciate you. You walk into the barn and they are happy to see you every single day. They are appreciative, it seems. I don't know... there is something truly special about them. I'm happy to see them and they're happy to see me. You really can't ask for anything better than that."

Having worked with hundreds of horses – superstars, claimers, and everything in between – throughout her time in racing, Dowis recalled gaining an early understanding of the benefits of creating a one-on-one relationship with each horse in the barn.

Although she somewhat resists the urge to pick out one particular horse that stands out above all the pacers and trotters she's worked alongside, a pacer who has gone on to become a millionaire just might top her list.

"I've taken care of a ton of them, and they really truly are so meaningful to me, but Workin Ona Mystery would probably be the one I've been the closest with. I had him with [trainer Brian Brown] and he made around \$700,000 during that time, and I never missed a race with him. I missed my brother's wedding to be there to watch him race. Nobody messed with that horse, he was mine. Other people might have owned him, but he was my horse."

A horse with as much personality as talent.

Bred by White Birch Farm, the son of Captaintreacherous—Dragons Tale won the first five starts of his 2-year-old season in 2018.

"He could be a little aggressive, but there was just something about him. When I worked with him, doing him up, putting him away, he would stand there and he loved to get attention. He's a colt, so he could be a little mean, but he was the one that when he saw you, it was as though he would say, 'Come here and let me mess with you.' We had a steel gate for him when we'd travel, his stall gate. We'd travel from Canada to Florida, to Jersey, and we needed that because he would always break them. He just wanted to see you and wanted that attention."

Showering her horses with affection has remained a constant over the years. So too has been daily conversations, albeit one sided, with them.

Never a problem for Dowis.

"People probably think I'm crazy because I talk to them from the moment I get in the morning until the time I leave. And it's all individual conversations."

There's a possibility Dowis could have those discussions with her very own horses one day.

"I would actually maybe like to train one or two on my own, but still work for Brian. I think I could handle one or two on my own, so that might be a goal. I worked for a lot of people since I started. I worked in New Jersey for a little bit. When I was there, I would just catch paddock a few, hang out, go to different barns and meet people. I would watch and then float. If they needed fill-ins, people to go to Lexington or Canada, they would hire me for however long they needed. I took [trotter and \$1.9 million earner] Lucky Jim to Canada for Andy and Julie Miller. I would do things like that. I wanted to learn how people did their job. It's different for every single stable. I've been able to use a lot of what I have learned from those days and put it into what I do. I'm really grateful for that."

As for personal pursuits outside of the racing world, Dowis doesn't have much time to explore hobbies and pastimes.

She does, however, continue to have all the time in the world for her horses.

And that suits her just fine.

"Well," she started, with a laugh. "My job, that's pretty much everything for me. When I'm home, I like to spend time with my nephews and nieces, who are involved in 4-H. I used to show livestock growing up and they are into it. I love being there. When they go show at the fairs, I'm there."

A rare guarantee considering Dowis' commitment to the horses she tends to.

Those she's closest with have come to understand appearances at family events is no sure bet.

"A lot of times, they'll call me to let me know something is going on, but more than likely I won't be there. I'm very close with my mom and dad. They love harness racing, and they are just fine with that. They really do understand, and I appreciate that." It's what being married to your job is all about.

France's Etonnant favored in MGM Yonkers International Trot

France's Etonnant, who earlier this year won the Elitloppet, drew post seven for Saturday's (Oct. 15) \$1 million MGM Yonkers International Trot and was made the 5-2 morning-line favorite in the invitational event that will bring together 10 horses from seven countries at Yonkers Raceway.

The race will be contested at the distance of 1-1/4 miles, with the horses in posts nine and 10 starting from the second tier. The draw for the event was conducted Tuesday at the Harvard Club in midtown Manhattan.

A son of the stallion Timoko, who finished second in the 2015 International Trot, Etonnant will have Anthony Barrier in the

sulky for owner/trainer Richard Westerink. He has won 20 of 81 races and earned more than \$2 million.

Most recently, Etonnant won at Vincennes on Sept. 10 at the 2,700-meter distance and has finished no worse than second in his previous five starts.

"I feel good," Westerink said. "The horse is good. We'll see if he can take the turns over here. We'll see in a couple of days. It's a little track for him.

"He's a very tough horse with a lot of speed. He is very strong. I think we can be maybe three wide and that's not a problem."

The Ake Svanstedt-trained duo of Denmark's Ecurie D and the United States' Back Of The Neck will start side-by-side in posts five and six, respectively.

Ecurie D, who won this year's Arthur J. Cutler Memorial in 1:49.1, the season's fastest mile, and captured last year's Breeders Crown Open Trot, is 3-1. Svanstedt will drive.

Back Of The Neck has won two of five starts this season, with the victories coming in the Maple Leaf Trot and Dayton Trotting Derby in his two most recent outings. Tim Tetrick will be at the lines for Back Of The Neck, who is 7-2.

"(The draw) could be better, but it could be worse also, so I'm happy," said Svanstedt, who won the 2016 International Trot with Resolve. "I think we have two good horses. Of course, it comes down to position and you must have a little luck also.

Denmark's Tycoon Conway Hall got post one and is 4-1. Kasper Foget is listed to drive for trainer Steen Juul.

Zacon Gio, who won the most recent International Trot in 2019, is back to defend his title after the event suffered two pandemic-related cancelations. Zacon Gio, who will have Roberto Vecchione driving for trainer Holger Ehlert, is 9-2.

Rounding out the field are Norway's Cokstile, the 2020 Elitloppet winner, who is 5-1, and Stoletheshow (8-1), Sweden's Kennedy (8-1), Canada's Lovedbythemasses (10-1), and the U.S.' second entrant, It's Academic (12-1).

There also will be two \$250,000 invitationals — the MGM Aria Pace and MGM Robert Miecuna Trot — on the International Trot Day card. Both will go with 10-horse fields and be raced at the distance of 1-1/4 miles.

The \$1 million MGM Yonkers International Trot (race seven) is scheduled for 3 p.m. (EDT) Saturday. It will be the first leg of a \$20,000 guaranteed Late Pick-4 (in conjunction with the USTA's Strategic Wagering Program), which also includes the Aria Pace and Robert Miecuna Trot as races eight and 10.

Westerink enjoying ride with Etonnant

Richard Westerink enjoys traveling, and his French standout Etonnant has brought him on an amazing journey this season.

Etonnant, an 8-year-old son of Westerink's champion Timoko, heads to Saturday's (Oct. 15) \$1 million MGM Yonkers International Trot at Yonkers Raceway with this year's Elitloppet title to his credit and nearly \$1.2 million in purses from 12 starts in 2022. He has finished no worse than second in nine of those races, winning five.

Over his past five starts, which date back to his Elitloppet triumph in Sweden on May 29, the stallion has three victories and two seconds, with the setbacks coming by a neck and a head to multiple Group 1 winner Vivid Wise As.

The trip to Yonkers brings Etonnant to his seventh different track in his fourth different country this season.

"I like to race over here; I love New York," said Westerink, who owns and trains Etonnant and is bringing a horse to the International Trot for the third time. "I love racing everywhere in the world. I like traveling. I like to do things other do not do.

"(Etonnant) is winning a lot of big races. I have a chance to race in the good races like that, and that's fun."

For his career, Etonnant has won 15 of 58 races and earned nearly \$1.9 million. Those numbers exclude five under-saddle victories, good for an additional half-million dollars. He has four Group 1 wins, three of which have come this year, including the Elitloppet.

"This is his best year," Westerink said. "Last year was very good also, but this year is exceptional. I think he's growing up and is a little bit stronger than before.

"He's not a trotting machine, like his father, but he's a very strong horse, a big horse."

Etonnant's win in the Elitloppet — a race Timoko captured twice — came after the stallion went off stride at the half and found himself in seventh place on the backstretch. He rallied with a four-wide move around the final turn and charged down the outside of the stretch to victory.

"It was amazing," Westerink said. "I said it was over (after the miscue) and then he won."



On Saturday, Etonnant will try to win one of the races that eluded his father. Timoko competed in the 2015 International Trot, which marked the return of the event after a 20-year absence, and finished second to Papagayo E.

Timoko raced on the outside for the entire distance of 1-1/4 miles while Papagayo E saved ground on the pylons before taking advantage of his pocket trip behind Creatine and bursting through the then-existing passing lane to win by a half-length.

"We were beaten when there was an open stretch," Westerink said. "(Timoko) went an amazing race."

Etonnant, out of the French mare Migraine, will start the International Trot from post seven (coincidently, the same as in the Elitloppet final) with regular driver Anthony Barrier and is the 5-2 morning-line favorite in the field of 10. Westerink was grateful for an outside starting position, admitting the half-mile oval at Yonkers is a concern.

"I'm afraid a little bit," Westerink said. "We'll see if he can take the turns over here. We'll see in a couple of days. It's a little track for him.

"I'm very happy with the (post). He can have a little bit of space on the outside in the first turn and then I hope we will see him up there on the front. He's a very tough horse with a lot of speed. I think we can be maybe three wide and that's not a problem."

Favorites have won three of the five editions of the International Trot since its renewal in 2015. Italy's Zacon Gio, one of those favorites, won the most recent of the International Trot in 2019 before two pandemic-related cancelations of the event. The 7-year-old stallion is back to defend his crown and will start from post 10 in the second tier on Saturday.

Racing begins at 12:30 p.m. (EDT). There also will be two \$250,000 invitationals — the MGM Aria Pace and MGM Robert Miecuna Trot — on the International Trot Day card. Both will go with 10-horse fields and be raced at the distance of 1-1/4 miles.

The International Trot (race seven) is scheduled for 3 p.m. It will be the first leg of a \$20,000 guaranteed Late Pick-4, which also includes the Aria Pace and Robert Miecuna Trot as races eight and 10, in conjunction with the USTA's Strategic Wagering Program.

A lunch buffet dining option is available on the second floor of the Empire Terrace at a cost of \$80 per person on MGM Yonkers International Trot Day. Tickets will be sold at the door, but advance reservations can be made by calling 609.317.7295.

There will be a Yonkers International Trot hat or T-shirt giveaway to the first 500 fans on the track apron.





Breaking down the European horses in the MGM Yonkers International Trot

It has been three long years since Zacon Gio won ahead of Slide So Easy and Marion Marauder in the 2019 MGM Yonkers International Trot and it's extremely satisfying to see such a quality field put together for the 2022 edition. Sure, it'd be nice to have seen Atlanta and maybe a few other stars, but this year's race, scheduled for Saturday (Oct. 15), is going to be a treat.

As many people from North America are unfamiliar with the European six-pack of horses hoping to take home the winner's share of the \$1 million purse, we'll cover each in detail below.

TYCOON CONWAY HALL

Representing Denmark, Tycoon Conway Hall drew a perfect post position. The horse born on Feb 11, 2010 is surely the best 12-year-old trotter in the world this year, having won in 1:52.1 and 1:52.3f earlier this year. In his final start before Yonkers, he easily won in 1:56f in Norway. The son of Conway Hall will make his 94th start in the MGM Yonkers International Trot. He can leave fast and is a good front-runner, yet is equally comfortable coming from behind. In fact, in both his 1:52.1 and two 1:52.3f wins this year, he's enjoyed cover well into the fourth quarter before unleashing his speed at the end.

Tycoon Conway Hall tends to be a bit undervalued in bigger races. Make no mistake about it, this is a very good trotter. If driver Kasper Foget wants to, he should take the lead. Reports in Danish media and interviews with Kasper and groom Rie Raun all suggest the Danish-born trotter is aiming for the lead. The probability of his succeeding at that is very high. The question is what happens after a quarter or so.

COKSTILE

The Norwegian duo of Cokstile and Stoletheshow find themselves in posts 3 and 4. Both have won European group 1 races in 2022 and cannot be underestimated. Cokstile was one

of the best in the crop at 3, and the following year established himself as one of the best when he won the Norwegian Derby. He was also second in the Jarlsberg Grand Prix in 1.52.3f, one of the fastest times by a 4-year-old in Europe that year. He started in the 2018 Elitlopp, but the season was a setback as injuries limited the horse to only 6 starts.

He started 2022 by winning the Prix de Bourgogne, defeating horses such as Vivid Wise As, Don Fanucci Zet, Davidson du Pont and Zacon Gio. In May he won the Finlandia Ajo and in September the Campionato Europeo in Cesena, Italy. Three different races, in three different countries, on three different track sizes – and with three different drivers. Cokstile is extremely versatile.

In his youth in Norway he was more of a front runner, but after being bought by his Italian owners was often given cover until unleashing his speed late. In the latter years he's also added something else to his repertoire, namely the ability to win after going first-over. That's how he won the Finlandia Ajo in 1:51.2f. It's also how he won the second heat, as well as the race-off of the Campionato Europeo. The 1:54.2h race-off win of the latter race was particularly impressive. Cokstile wasn't merely parked outside. He was pressing incessantly until a completely worn-down stablemate Usain Toll hoisted the white flag and begged for mercy in the last turn. After such a performance the ambitions were high in the Lotteria, but he only finished fourth in his elimination and missed out on the final.

That performance is the question-mark: Is Cokstile's current form good enough? Cokstile can challenge for the lead, although I don't think he's fast enough to get the lead before the first turn. Dell'Annunziata rarely bothers going all-out from the start, and I don't see it happening here either. He might end up being parked outside, and if not he may just get great cover. Either way it doesn't matter too much, because a Cokstile in top form is good enough to win this race regardless of the trip.

STOLETHESHOW

The Dream Vacation son Stoletheshow won the Norwegian Criterium at 3, and although he was good, he couldn't quite follow up at 4. The colt continued to do well at 5, finishing second in the group 1 race Jubileumspokalen and winning another race in 1:53.3f, but he was seemingly a tiny notch below the best. It didn't go too much better in 2021 when he was winless come mid-September. That's when owner Suleyman Yuksel decided to move the horse to a new trainer.

In the hands of Norwegian champion trainer Frode Hamre, the horse has blossomed into an absolute star. Hamre knew the horse had plenty of ability and instead set out on building him up mentally. In his first two starts, Stoletheshow twice lost to stablemate Ble du Gers. On both occasions Hamre surrendered the lead to Ble du Gers and seemingly didn't challenge too intensely down the final stretch. Some bettors even complained

that he wasn't actively trying to win the races. However, the relatively soft-spoken and smart trainer had a plan for his new trotter, one that would soon catapult the now 7-year-old colt to stardom.

A few easy wins against easy opposition followed before Hamre reintroduced him against the Swedish elite in February. An encouraging second-place, where he also finished ahead of Ble du Gers, has been followed by a string of consistent top-rate performances. In total, the horse has started 17 times for Hamre, winning 8, finishing 15 in the top-3 and all of them inside the top-4. The highlights include winning the group 1-races Oslo Grand Prix and Ulf Thoresen Grand International.

Stoletheshow was relatively fortunate with his post in the International Trot and is the one horse in the field where the morning-line odds should be ignored. The horse can leave fast. He may just be fast enough to get past Tycoon Conway Hall, but even if he doesn't get to the front before the first turn I fully expect Hamre to keep pressing until he gets there. Well in front this can get very interesting, because Stoletheshow has great curve technique and is reportedly in absolute top form. If that is the case, and he doesn't have to burn too much energy getting to the lead, it will take somebody quite special to defeat him.

ETONNANT

In a field full of special horses, nobody is more special than the aptly-named Etonnant, French for amazing or astonishing. On raw ability alone, Etonnant would win. Forget 1:49 on a fast Pocono or Meadowlands — or anything else for that matter. Etonnant's 1:51.3f in the Elitlopp final is much more impressive than it sounds. From post 7, with a break on the backstretch, Etonnant put in a massive effort. The Timoko son never saw the rail, being three-wide in the second turn and four-wide in the final turn. Informal calculations, correcting for the much longer trip, have found that the horse in reality was close to a 1:49 clocking (had he stayed trotting and ran along the pylons the whole race).

It takes something special to win the International Trot and Etonnant surely has it. Unfortunately, he's special in other ways, too. His gait isn't always the smoothest and Etonnant's curve technique leaves a lot to be desired. It's never a problem on the bigger French racetracks, but it was evident at Solvalla. On the even smaller Yonkers track, it's surely the question of the day on race-day. If Etonnant gets around the curves without too much trouble, he's the obvious candidate for the win. How realistic is that, though?

KENNEDY

Kennedy had the eyes of Swedish trotting all over him for quite a while. The blue-blooded colt is the second foal from Lou Guida's stellar Italian-born mare Lisa America, a multiple group 1-winner in Europe. For a long while, however, Kennedy was decent but nothing more. After six wins in 52 starts and earnings surely

below his yearling price tag, the Swedish-born horse was sold to a group of Danish owners. They sent him to Erik Bondo, a Dane based in Italy who has enjoyed massive success on the continent for many years. Bondo has only started Kennedy in France, where 12 starts have yielded seven wins and two second places.

The 7-year-old has put in some very good performances in France, and posted five wins in a row from March to June. He finished eighth in the Aby Stora Pris in August and was "only" fifth in his last start at Vincennes in late September. As a result there are some question marks over his form. The obvious objection to Kennedy, however, is that he's completely unproven at this level.

Kennedy usually doesn't leave too fast, but is often used in the middle section. I am far from confident he can stay on Tycoon Conway Hall's back in the early stages, and he might end up too far back to have a good shot at a top-3 finish. However, he's not a bad horse. It's hard to see how he can win this, but from post 9 it wouldn't be a surprise if he picked up a check.

ZACON GIO

He went from a very good 4-year-old in Italy to an overnight international star when he won the MGM Yonkers International Trot in 2019. After his big Yonkers win, the son of Ruty Grif has tried his luck in France several times. The paternal grandson of Varenne isn't, however, suited to the longer distances or the unique racetrack at Vincennes, something a single third place in seven starts indicate. However, he's really at home at a half-mile track like Yonkers.

Fortunately, the form seems really good. Fourth and secondplace finishes in the two heats of the Campionato Europeo was followed by an elimination win in the Lotteria. In the final he finished a very credible third and underscored his great form.

Post 10 was probably the worst he could draw. With this starting position, he's completely at the mercy of his opponents. He's very likely to sit far back at the quarter pole. Zacon Gio is a great front-runner but also possesses a lethal finish, something he demonstrated in the 2019 edition. However, he's not a horse to sit parked outside or going three-wide for a very long distance.

PREDICTION:

Needless to say, my top-4 prediction is based on Etonnant not feeling at home on a half-mile track.

- 4 Stoletheshow Unless he gets too much pressure in the middle section, he's a potential winner.
- 6 Back of the Neck He seems to be in great shape and impressed at Dayton.
- 5 Ecurie D He has question marks all over him, but he has a decent post position and Ake will surely have him sharp for this race.
- 1 Tycoon Conway Hall Seems bound for a top-4 finish but I don't see him as a winner.





Bax trotters ready for Ontario Sires Stakes Super Final night

Terrific trotting 2-year-olds is a tongue twister that doubles as the 2022 slogan for John Bax's stable.

Heading into the Ontario Sires Stakes Gold Super Finals on Saturday (Oct. 15) at Woodbine Mohawk Park, Bax has a five-pack of freshman trotters taking aim at the winner's share of the \$225,000 purses they are competing for.

Leading the way is star filly Righteous Resolve. The Bet Max Stables Inc. and Benenati Inc. homebred has been nearly flawless, winning seven times from eight starts, including a trio of OSS Gold wins, a sweep of the Peaceful Way elimination and final, and a stakes record romp in the Champlain.

"I trained her in Florida, and she wasn't anything special, but a month after being home she switched on and away she went," said Bax. "It's all different, some you know right away and other one's surprise you."

Righteous Resolve is a full sister to 2021 O'Brien Award winner Duly Resolved and is by Resolve out of the stakes winning Muscle Mass mare Muscle Town.

"What makes her special is that she is versatile," said Bax. "She's pretty push button. (Driver Paul MacDonell) can leave with her, he can sit back with her, he can kind of go when he wants. That always makes quite a difference when you can race a horse different ways. If you always race them one way everyone catches on and it's a little tougher. What makes a good horse a better horse is usually that they are versatile."

MacDonell will be in the bike on Saturday night, leaving from post three as Righteous Resolve looks to improve on her impressive \$423,724 in earnings to date. Bax, a resident of Campbellville, ON, is also harnessing Its Your Choice. The Muscle Mass filly has six on the board finishes in seven starts this year but has yet to break into the winner's circle. James MacDonald will pilot Its Your Choice from post six. She is owned by Al Libfield, Marvin Katz, and Lynn Katz.

On the male side of the juvenile trotting division, Snowpiercer and Oh Look Magic both look threatening heading into the Super Final.

"Training down we thought Snowpiercer was pretty special, and were a little surprised by Oh Look Magic," said Bax. "He kept going with everybody but you're thinking he will hit a wall sooner or later, but he never did."

Snowpiercer, a \$130,000 purchase at the 2021 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale, picked up a pair of Gold wins early in the campaign. The Muscle Mass colt draws in to post eight, with Paul MacDonell driving for owners Bax Stable, Bradley Grant, David Anderson, and Richard Gutnick.

Oh Look Magic, a Glengate Farms homebred co-owned by Bax Stable and Cavalier Stable, threatened early in the Mohawk Million, but after a hard working parked out first quarter to make the lead, was unable to hang on when the field spun for home.

The Lookslikeacphndale gelding has won four times this year, and three have come from on the lead at the quarter pole. Matt Bax will drive him from post nine on Saturday night.

"You usually have to let him do his thing off the gate, and then after that he's a little easier to handle," said Bax. "If they move along, he can sit in a hole and be good. He's got the outside, so we will see how it transpires. At this point in the year, you like to say everything is a bonus."





The final Bax two-year-old trotter is Deadline Hall. From nine starts the Muscle Mass gelding has a record of 0-2-1 and has amassed \$46,378 in earnings for owners Bax Stable, Steve Organ, and Rick Heinz. Chris Christoforou will drive from post three.

Bax's sixth and final starter of the night is in the three-year-old trotting colts and geldings division, and it's a familiar name to fans of the OSS, Duly Resolved.

The runner-up in the 2021 Super Final is coming off an impressive outing in London at The Raceway at the Western Fair District where he set an all ages trotting track record of 1:55.4.

"Duly Resolved raced super last week in London. My daughter is an animal osteopath and she's been working hard on him, and a lot of them," said Bax. "We think that is a big benefit. With Duly Resolved we had stomach and allergy issues, but he seems to be coming around now. So, I am hoping for a good end of the year with him."

The final piece of the puzzle for Bax on Saturday night, comes in the form of the season long Johnston Cup, awarded to the top trainer in the Ontario Sires Stakes, one of the few accolades that has evaded the veteran trainer.

"It would be nice. I look more at the dollar signs on the righthand side than the points," said Bax. "But it would obviously feel pretty good. It's always nice to be up there.

LANE READY TO SOAK IN SUPER FINAL WITH HORSE OF A LIFETIME

One of the beautiful things about harness racing is it has something for everyone. Participants can chase million dollar purses, try for open stakes glory, race in the claiming ranks at their local racetrack, and a enjoy a host of possibilities in between.

In Saturday's \$225,000 Ontario Sires Stakes Gold Super Final for 3-year-old pacing fillies at Woodbine Mohawk Park, Goudawon will give Brenda Lane the chance to experience a new level of the game.

"When she won a (Gold division) this year, that was the largest purse we had ever raced for," said Lane. "I thought I would be very nervous and stressed, but then I thought you know what, I can't really do anything about it, and it was great fun. When she won it was like wow. So, it's just really exciting."

Goudawon enters the Super Final with a 2022 record of 5-0-7 from 19 starts and \$161,410 in earnings. Her Gold score came in a \$157,200 division at Woodbine Mohawk Park on July 9.

On Saturday night, Lane, a veteran horseperson with over 1100 training starts for just under \$550,000 in career earnings, is entering unfamiliar territory as she guns for Super Final success.

"I have never had a horse like this before," said Lane. "It has been so great. I remember the night she won her Gold; we knew she had to have a trip to win, and it just worked out in our favour, but that's horse racing too. On the way home we were just saying I still can't believe that she won it."

Lane and her husband Mark bred Goudawon out of their retired Camluck race mare Keystone Samurai, and they co-own the daughter of Betterthancheddar with their son, Anthony.

Residents of Roseneath, ON, the Lanes purchased Keystone Samurai during her 9-year-old season and campaigned her primarily at nearby Kawartha Downs until she was 12, retiring her in 2017 with 248 starts and \$169,136 in earnings.

When they downsized their farm, she was the mare they decided to keep.

"She was just such a nice mare to be around," said Lane. "When we picked one that we wanted to keep, she was just personality wise amazing, and the fact she is a Camluck mare, she was the one we kept. Then being a Camluck mare we decided to breed her."

Goudawon is the second foal out of Keystone Samurai, after Goudawon's full-brother Havartiwon in 2018. The Lane's racing stable currently consists of those two siblings, and Keystone Samurai makes their broodmare band a solo act.

Lane was on the farm when Goudawon foaled out and has enjoyed every step of her OSS success. Last season, she won at the Grassroots level, and she has a Grassroots win, and a pair of Gold thirds to go along with her top-level victory this year.


"We've had a lot of interest in people trying to buy her from us, right from when she was two and we kind of decided no, we just want to keep her," said Lane. "It's unexpected, because when we breed for them, we just want a nice racehorse, and this is like something you dream of."

Goudawon is in tough on Saturday night, as she races for the biggest purse of her career. The Murray Brethour trainee has drawn post nine in the field of ten and will face off against 2021 O'Brien Award winner Prohibition Legal, who headlines a trio of Millar Farms homebreds with five Gold division victories between them this year. Bob McClure will be in the race bike.

"If she gets the right trip, she is competitive," said Lane. "With the right trip any of them can win the race, that's the way I look at it. Some of the fillies can get a harder trip and win, but most of the fillies in there, I figure they are all the type of horses you don't want to race against."

Saturday night will be a family affair for the Lanes. The wife, husband, and son ownership partners will be joined by Lane's daughter Amanda Riley, and her husband Tom Riley. Tom recently earned the 2022 training title at Kawartha Downs.

"I just think it's going to be a great night," said Lane. "You have lots of owners that come and it's kind of what everyone strives for when you're racing and going into stakes races. It is going to be very exciting."

Captain Cowgirl, a Pennsylvania Sires Stakes Champion at both 2 and 3, has put together an impressive trio of victories including the \$253,000 Pennsylvania Sires Stake Championship on Sept. 25. The Jim King, Jr. trainee has compiled 12 victories and two runner-up finishes in 19 career starts, good for \$569,875 in purses. Hall of Fame driver Tim Tetrick will be in the sulky behind the 2-1 morning-line favorite.

Lookatmyrapsheet checks in as the 7-2 second choice. The daughter of Bettor's Delight has won five races and finished in the top-three in 12 of 14 starts this year. Her most recent score came earlier this month at The Red Mile, winning in 1:51.1. Trainer Per Engblom ships his filly in from Kentucky and has listed Ronnie Wrenn Jr. to pilot from post four.

Two Ohio-sired fillies have been invited to this year's event. Cape Cod Hanover, winner of the \$103,714 Ohio Breeders Championship last month, is the 4-1 third favorite from post three.
