Let's hope we haven't seen the last of The International Trot, but if we have, it's important to take a moment to give major kudos to much-maligned Yonkers Raceway for the effort.

Five years ago, Tim Rooney and company revived one of harness racing's greatest events and poured considerable money into making it the world class event it has always been.

For all those that suggest the money would have been better spent on overnights, you're missing the point, especially since overnight money is plentiful at Yonkers.

A lot of the griping, it seems, is based on the fact much of the sizeable purse money has left these shores, which also misses the point.

This was always about opening new markets, particularly for betting, in the hope of growing handle. As we know, the more money there is in the pools, the more people will want to bet on your product. In an age of purses fattened with proceeds from casino gaming — an arrangement surely doomed to a short future one politicians start meddling the only way the sport can reach true independence and a

sustainable future is to grow its own handle.

The International certainly took a good stab at tapping into the rich betting systems in France and Scandinavia.

Beyond betting, The International was also an attempt to shrink the harness racing world, learn as much as possible from each other and strengthen both harness racing alliances and the Yonkers brand.

Was any of it as successful as organizers hoped? Probably not, but that's half-mile track racing for you. The configuration will always be Yonkers' biggest albatross.

I speak of The International in the past tense here on purpose because far too often casino companies are far too predictable. Will Yonkers' corporate master MGM Resorts — which courts share price, not horsepeople — decide it's worth investing serious coin in a race non-harness racing people know and care little about? Doubtful, especially since I imagine the business case isn't strong.

But that doesn't mean harness racing as an enterprise shouldn't rally behind The International concept.

In a perfect world, if Yonkers can't keep The International it would be wonderful to see it on a big track at the

Meadowlands or Woodbine Mohawk Park. The Meadowlands, in particular, would be a great fit seeing as the race has always been in the New York area and opening up international markets was always a passion and great labor of the Big M's late Sam McKee. To continue his work would be fitting to his legacy and would surely benefit the Meadowlands long-term.

Yes, the Meadowlands' own stakes program and purse structure isn't what it once was and needs attention first. Yes, there isn't a casino at the Meadowlands. Yes, sports betting alone won't cut it for an event of this scope. Yes, The International is an expensive exercise needing many years of sustained commitment. Yes, a million-dollar purse and generous entertainment budget— both necessary for drawing the Europeans across the ocean — is a big nut. I realize those are serious challenges.

But in a time where small thinking has produced a small industry, isn't it time to back the alternative?

Three supplement to Breeders Crown; France's Bold Eagle also in

Custom Cantab, Century Farroh and Southwind Ozzi have supplemented to the Crown. Bold Eagle is a foreign invitee.

The wide-open sophomore pacing colt landscape and a sparkling performance in the Ontario Sires Stake (OSS) 3-year-old filly pace Super Final triggered three supplements to those respective divisions. Trotting mare **Custom Cantab** will also start in the \$300,000 Breeders Crown Mare Trot via the supplemental entry route.

Also, **Bold Eagle**, the lone foreign classic invitee to declare, has been entered in the \$500,000 Breeders Crown Open Trot set for Saturday, Oct. 26.

The connections of **Century Farroh** and **Southwind Ozzi** each anted up \$62,500 to enter the \$500,000 Breeders Crown 3-Year-Old Colt Pace, as did the owners of filly pacer Boadicea.

Southwind Ozzi has staked a claim to divisional leadership with a seasonal bankroll of \$804,435 and recent wins in the Little Brown Jug and Adios. The son of Crown champion Somebeachsomewhere was recently beaten a head Lexington by Dancin Lou in 1:49.4, but a qualifier at Freehold in 1:56.2 satisfied trainer Bill MacKenzie that a supplement was justified.

"He was just fine," said MacKenzie, who trains for owners Vincent Ali Jr. and Alma Iafelice, when he dropped off the check after the qualifier at Freehold Raceway. "Basically a training mile."

Century Farroh, who has raced primarily in Ontario, and like Southwind Ozzi did not race in the Breeders Crown as a 2-year-old, has also racked up an impressive record for trainer Ian Moore and owners the Ratchford Stable NS. Though he was third beaten a length in his last start, the Ontario Sires Stake Super Final, which saw a mad dash to the wire and an upset win by B Stoney, Century Farroh has picked up \$573,570 this year and certainly earned a start in his divisional Crown event.

Boadicea, a sophomore daughter of Crown champion Big Jim, crushed foes with a 1:49.2 mile in her Ontario final at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Saturday. Her record of 11 wins in 18 starts and her sharp recent form for trainer Bill Budd and an exuberant group of Lawrence Stable owners saw her supplemented for \$62,500 to the \$500,000 3-Year-Old Filly Pace. She will face defending divisional and Crown champion Warrawee Ubeaut among others.



Custom Cantab, a 4-year old daughter of Mr Cantab, surged past the million-dollar earnings mark for trainer Chris Beaver with a second-place finish in the \$250,000 Harry Harvey Trot to male trotter Mission Accepted. Her ownership of Beaver, Robinson and RBH Ventures will pay \$31,250 to start in the \$300,000 Mare Trot.

Last, but the farthest from least, is foreign invitee Bold Eagle. The 8-year-old son of Ready Cash—Reethi Rah Jet has won 45 times against the toughest of European competition and banked more than \$5 million. He has been invited three times to the Breeders Crown, and his racing schedule and the travel conditions finally aligned for Bold Eagle to ship to Canada for the Crown. He is the first foreign classic winner to accept an invitation since Commander Crowe came triumphantly to the Meadowlands in 2014.

Foreign invitees must make up the same schedule of payments as eligible horses and pay the starting fee, but advance directly to the final if there are eliminations, and are placed in the open post-position draw. With current driver Bjorn Goop unavailable due to a racing conflict, Hall of Famer Brian Sears has been tapped to drive the European champion.

Rookies to clash in Friday Crown eliminations

Filly pacer Lyons Sentinel, this season's richest 2-year-old, as well as undefeated divisional money-leaders Tall Dark Stranger, Real Cool Sam, and Hypnotic AM were among 63 freshmen entered Tuesday for the \$6 million Breeders Crown at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Eliminations for the 2-year-olds, which are necessary in all four divisions and go for a purse of \$25,000 each, are Friday at Mohawk. Post time for Friday's first race is 7:50 p.m. (EDT). The \$600,000 finals for 2-year-olds will be Oct. 25 at Mohawk, with an early 7 p.m. post time.

Breeders Crown eliminations for 3-year-olds and up are Saturday at Mohawk.

Elimination winners, in an order determined by lot, draw for post positions one through five for the finals. The draws for the 2-year-old finals, except for the colt-and-gelding pace, will be conducted Friday following the eliminations. The draw for the colt-and-gelding pace will be Tuesday at the post-position draw and press conference at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Twelve horses were entered for the 2-year-old colt-and-gelding pace, with the connections of Capt Midnight and Catch The Fire accepting earnings-based byes to advance directly to the final. The top eight finishers from the remaining 10-horse elimination will join those two in the final.

Capt Midnight, by Captaintreacherous, has won multiple Grand Circuit stakes for trainer Tony Alagna. Catch The Fire, also by Captaintreacherous and trained by John Ackley, is a Kentucky Sire Stakes champion.

The connections of Tall Dark Stranger and Papi Rob Hanover declined a bye.

Tall Dark Stranger is unbeaten in seven starts for trainer Nancy Johansson, with his wins including the Metro Pace at Mohawk. A son of Bettor's Delight, the colt has earned \$411,265 this season. He starts the elim from post four.

Papi Rob Hanover, trained by Brett Pelling, counts the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes championship among his three wins in eight starts. The son of Somebeachsomewhere finished second in the Metro and has earned \$315,358. He leaves from post six.

Thirteen horses were entered for the 2-year-old colt-and-gelding trot, with the connections of Real Cool Sam, Port Perry, and Capricornus accepting byes to advance directly to the final. The top seven finishers from the remaining 10-horse field will join that trio next week.

Real Cool Sam, the Peter Haughton Memorial and Pennsylvania Sire Stakes champion, is unbeaten in nine races. Trained by Jim Campbell, the son of Muscle Hill has earned \$454,575. Ontario Sire Stakes final runner-up Port Perry, a son of Kadabra, has earned \$224,090 for trainer Luc Blais while William Wellwood Memorial runner-up Capricornus, by Cantab Hall, has earned \$192,885 for trainer Marcus Melander.

Two-time Grand Circuit-winner Amigo Volo, a son of Father Patrick trained by Richard "Nifty" Norman and Carter Pinske, will start the elimination from post three. New York Sire Stakes champion Third Shift, a son of Chapter Seven, leaves from post one for Ake Svanstedt. Ontario Sire Stakes champ Moon Bridge, a son of E L Titan also from Svanstedt's stable, starts from post seven.

Twenty-one 2-year-old filly pacers entered the Breeders Crown, requiring three eliminations. The top three finishers from each elimination plus the fourth-place finisher with the highest earnings as calculated by Standardbred Canada advance to the final.

Lyons Sentinel, a daughter of Captaintreacherous trained by Jim King Jr., is in the third elim. She has won seven of 10 races this year and finished no worse than second in any start, earning \$519,255. She brings a six-race win streak to her Breeders Crown elimination, with her victories including the She's A Great Lady at Mohawk and the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes championship.

Ontario Sire Stakes champion Alicorn, trained by Chantel Mitchell, is in the second elimination while the first elim includes Indiana Sire Stakes champ Priceless, from the stable of Brandon Bates.

Seventeen 2-year-old filly trotters were divided into two eliminations, with James Doherty Memorial and New York Sire Stakes champion Hypnotic AM in the first. Hypnotic AM, by Chapter Seven, has won all seven of her races this season and earned \$386,457 for trainer Marcus Melander. Also in the first elim is Pennsylvania Sire Stakes champion Sister Sledge, trained by Ron Burke.

The second elimination includes Peaceful Way winner Dip Me Hanover, trained by Linda Toscano, and multiple Grand Circuit winner Sherry Lyns Lady, trained by Jim Campbell. The top five finishers from each elimination advance to the final.

Breeders Crown paths set for sophomores and older

Divisional supremacy and international glory will be on the line in the eight Breeders Crown events for 3-year-olds and up at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

All four sophomore divisions will require eliminations this Saturday (Oct. 19), while only the Mare Trot from the older ranks will need eliminations.

The 3-year-old colt pace (15 entrants) and 3-year-old filly trot (16 entrants) will have two eliminations each on Saturday's card, while the sophomore trotting colts (12 entrants) and pacing fillies (12 entrants) will each feature just a single elimination after two byes were issued in each event.

The Mare Trot attracted 15 ladies and will need two eliminations to determine its final field. The Open Trot (11 entrants), Open Pace (10 entrants) and Mare Pace (7 entrants) will all headline directly to a final on October 26.

A total of eight elimination races will take place on this Saturday's (Oct. 19) card at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Saturday battles for Crown spots

Trainer Marcus Melander will send his three-headed monster of sophomore trotting colts Greenshoe, Green Manalishi S and Gimpanzee to Woodbine Mohawk Park for the Breeders Crown.

Only a single ten-horse elimination is needed in the **3-Year-Old Colt Trot** division, as 12 horses were entered. The top-two earners in 2019 received byes, while the other ten entered will compete to eliminate two ahead of the **\$500,000 (USD) final**.

Melander opted to take the bye with the division-leader Greenshoe, who has banked over \$1.1 million this season. Hambletonian champion Forbidden Trade received the second bye, which was accepted by trainer Luc Blais. The Ontario Sires Stakes champion is eight for 13 with \$1 million earned.

Green Manalishi S headlines Saturday's elimination from post-two. The son of Muscle Hill is undefeated in four starts at Woodbine Mohawk Park, capturing this year's Canadian Trotting Classic and last year's William Wellwood Memorial.

Gimpanzee has drawn post-four for the elimination, as the son of Chapter Seven attempts to become a two-time Breeders Crown champion. The New York Sires Stakes champion won last year's 2-Year-Old Colt Trot final in convincing fashion and enters this year's event having won 15 of 19 career starts.

The elimination field for the 3-Year-Old Colt Trot Breeders Crown also includes Dont Letem (post-five), Marseille (post-nine) and Pilot Discretion (post-ten). All three trotters have posted strong results in marquee events this season.

The single-elimination for sophomore trotting colts and geldings has been carded as Race 5 on Saturday's card.

The **3-Year-Old-Colt Pace** division is a wide-open affair with a group of 15 separated into a pair of eliminations.

Pepsi North America Cup winner Captain Crunch has won just two of seven starts since his classic victory in June at Woodbine Mohawk Park. The Nancy Johansson trained son of Captaintreacherous has been knocking on the door in his last two starts, posting runner-up finishes in each. The defending Breeders Crown champion has drawn post-two in the first elimination.

Captain Crunch will tackle the likes of Meadowlands Pace winner Best In Show (post-eight), Tattersalls winner Dancin Lou (post-three) and multiple Grand Circuit stakes winner Century Farroh (post-one), who was supplemented Monday by his connections for \$62,500 (USD).

The ultra-consistent Bettors Wish (post-one) will square-off with Little Brown Jug champion Southwind Ozzi (post-three) in the second elimination.

Chris Ryder trainee Bettors Wish has won 11 of 15 starts this season, including the Art Rooney, Milstein Memorial, Kentucky Sires Stakes championship and Tattersalls. The son of Bettors Delight has finished in the runner-up spot in all four of his defeats this season.

Southwind Ozzi rose to stardom this summer for trainer Bill MacKenzie by posting victories in marquee events such as the Adios and Little Brown Jug. The son of Somebeachsomewhere has won nine of 12 starts and earned the confidence from his connections to put up \$62,500 (USD) to supplement to the Breeders Crown.

The top-five finishers from each 3-Year-Old Pacing Colt elimination will advance to the \$600,000 (USD) final.

Trainer Ron Burke turned down a bye and will race defending Breeders Crown champion Warrawee Ubeaut in Saturday's single-elimination for the **3-Year-Old Filly Pace** event. Tony Alagna's Treacherous Reign and Bob McIntosh's Sunny Dee received byes from the group of 12 entered, which sets up a ten-horse division to eliminate two for the **\$550,000 (USD) final**.

Warrawee Ubeaut (post-six) powers into her elimination on a six-race win streak, which includes scores in the

Pennsylvania Sires Stakes championship, Jugette and Glen Garnsey Memorial. The daughter of Sweet Lou has won 10 of 15 this season and is a 13-time winner with over \$1.3 million earned.

The sophomore pacing filly elimination will also feature Ontario Sires Stakes champion Boadicea (post-nine). The Bill Budd trained daughter of Big Jim was supplemented on Monday to the event by her owners for a fee of \$62,500 (USD).

Standouts Stonebridge Soul (post-two), Tall Drink Hanover (post-five) and Queen Of The Pride (post-eight) will also compete.

The elimination for 3-year-old pacing fillies has been carded as Race 8.

A competitive group of 16 has been split into a pair of eliminations for the **3-Year-Old Filly Trot** Crown event. The top-five finishers from each division will advance to the **\$500,000 (USD)** final.

Elegantimage winner Evident Beauty (post-one) for trainer 'Nifty' Norman, Zweig Memorial winner The Ice Dutchess (post-two) for trainer Johansson and Ohio Sires Stakes champion Only Take Cash (post-three) for trainer McIntosh will all meet in the first elimination.

The second elimination will feature a matchup between Hambletonian Oaks champion When Dovescry (post-two) for trainer Rene Allard and Kentucky Filly Futurity winner Beautiful Sin (post-eight) for trainer Ake Svanstedt. Those two will also have to deal with Millies Possesion (post-three), who has won 10 of 13 starts for trainer Jim Campbell.

The sophomore trotting fillies will clash in Races 2 and 3 on Saturday's card.

A strong turnout of 15 older trotting mares will allow fans the opportunity to see several superstars in action during this weekend's eliminations for the \$325,000 (USD) Mare Trot.

Four-year-old Manchego storms into Woodbine Mohawk Park on a three-race win streak, highlighted by a World Record 1:49 victory in the Allerage. The Nancy Johansson trainee is a 24-time winner and captured the Breeders Crown at age two in 2017. She'll line up from post-eight in Saturday's second elimination.

A pair of two-time Crown champions will compete in the deep Mare Trot division.

Emoticon Hanover is going for a three-peat in the event after victories last year at Pocono and in 2017 at Hoosier. The Luc Blais trained six-year-old has won 24 of 68 career starts, hitting the board in 51 of those outings. She tackles Manchego from post-three in the second split.

Former Horse of the Year Hannelore Hanover returns to the Mare Trot Crown division for the first time since 2016. The Ron Burke trained seven-year-old captured the Open Trot division in 2017 and the Mare Trot division in 2016. She is a 46-time winner with over \$3.2 million (CAD) in career earnings.

Hannelore Hanover lines up from post-six in the first elimination, which also features local standout Dream Together (post-one), supplement entry Custom Cantab (post-three) and the Svanstedt duo of Darling Mearas S (post-two) and Plunge Blue Chip (post-seven).

The Mare Trot Breeders Crown eliminations have been carded as Races 6 and 9.

Harness racing heavyweights head straight to Crown finals

A trio of events for older competitors will not require eliminations this weekend.

Foreign classic invitee Bold Eagle will star in the **\$500,000 (USD) Open Trot**. The 8-year-old son of Ready Cash will take on 10 rivals in his North American debut, seeking to add a Crown title to his incredible legacy. Hall of Fame driver Brian Sears will steer the winner of over \$5 million for trainer Sébastien Guarato.

France's Bold Eagle is the first foreign classic winner to accept a Breeders Crown invitation since Commander Crowe in 2014, who won the Open Trot at The Meadowlands.

Four-year-old mare Atlanta has earned the confidence of her connections to take another crack at the boys in a classic event. The 2018 Hambletonian champion and winner of nearly \$2 million will attempt to steal the attention of the trotting world from Bold Eagle and claim the Open Trot title for a 20th career victory.

This season's highest earner in the Open Trot is Anette



Lorentzon trainee Guardian Angel As, who scored the biggest victory of his career earlier this season at Woodbine Mohawk Park. The five-year-old stallion captured the Maple Leaf Trot on August 31 and most recently finished fourth in the Yonkers International Trot.

The Open Trot star power also includes world champion Six Pack, 2016 Hambletonian champion Marion Marauder and 2017 Breeders Crown champion Fiftydallarbill. The event is completed by Dunbar Hall, Mission Accepted, Southwind Chrome and Will Take Charge.

Reigning Horse of the Year McWicked is back to defend his title in the \$500,000 (USD) Open Pace and is seeking a third Breeders Crown victory. The Casie Coleman trained eight-year-old went four years between Crown victories after winning at age three and again last season. McWicked enters off back-to-back victories in the Allerage and Rooney Invitational.

The 10-horse Open Pace field includes two former Little Brown Jug champions in Courtly Choice and Filibuster Hanover. Blake MacIntosh trained four-year-old Courtly Choice scored an upset win earlier this season at Woodbine Mohawk Park in the Canadian Pacing Derby.

Hometown favourite Jimmy Freight will make his Breeders Crown debut in the Open Pace. The 5-year-old is a 21-time winner and has finished outside the top-five only once in 50 career starts.

The field for the pacing heavyweight clash is completed by Always a Prince, American History, Dorsoduro Hanover, Easy Lover Hanover, Geez Joe and This Is The Plan.

Shartin N returns to the **\$300,000 (USD) Mare Pace** with eyes on a second-consecutive Breeders Crown victory. The six-year-old New Zealand bred has won 14 of 16 starts this season, frequently crushing her foes and earning much buzz as potential Horse of the Year. The Jim King Jr. trainee is undefeated in four starts at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

sweeping the last two editions of the Roses Are Red.

While nearly flawless, Shartin N did taste defeat in her most recent start, finishing second to rival Caviart Ally in the Allerage at The Red Mile. The superstar mares finished in the opposite order in last year's Crown event.

A 5-year-old, Caviart Ally has seven wins and top-three finishes in all 16 starts this season. The Brett Pelling trainee captured her second-consecutive Milton Stakes last month at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The Mare Pace field also includes 2017 Breeders Crown champion Youaremycandygirl, and Dan Patch Award winner Kissin In The Sand. Bettors Up, Kaitlyn N and Kendall Seelster will also compete.

Elimination and draw details set

Breeders Crown 2-year-old eliminations will be held Friday (Oct. 18) and the sophomore and open divisions requiring eliminations will race Saturday (Oct. 19). Elimination winners draw for inside post positions 1-5. Post positions will be drawn on Friday and Saturday after the elimination races, except for the 2-year-old Colt Pace, Crown Pace and Crown Trot. Those three events will be drawn at a Press Conference next Tuesday (Oct. 22).

Post time for Friday's (Oct. 18) card is 7:50 p.m., while Saturday's (Oct. 19) post time is set for 7:10 p.m.

Hanover's yearling sales philosophy, compensation for use of a name and thoughts on the reign of Somebeachsomewhere

I should know better than to expect to get an error, let alone four of them, by Hanover's Dr. Bridgette Jablonsky.

In my last column, I answered a question from Clay Horner. When it was pointed out that my answer contained those errors, my editor removed that part of my column until I could correct the record, which is why that section no longer appears in the online issue.

However, it is important to note:

- 1. Mayhem Hanover was Musicale Hanover's second foal, but her first colt.
- 2. Capt Midnight sold as a yearling for \$350,000, not \$375,000.
- 3. Social Scene was not in foal to Captaintreacherous when Hanover bought her. She was subsequently bred to him at Myron Bell's request/suggestion.
- 4. Bedroom Confessions was purchased already in foal to Captaintreacherous. Thus Myron and Stephanie Bell are officially the breeders of the spectacular filly she has at her side, although she was foaled at, is being raised by and will be sold as a yearling by Hanover.

A lesson thoroughly learned.

Never try (even unintentionally) to get anything, especially concerning Hanover, by Dr. J.

Perhaps more importantly, do not rely on my long ago almost perfect memory. That was then. This is now. The overriding need is to check and then double everything that I write.

Hanover's yearling sales philosophy

I was recently asked to discuss some of my past experience at Hanover in the yearling sector.

Before I go any further, I need to mention that different people who breed and sell yearlings have different goals, needs and motivations.

I respect them all and understand most of them.

In my opinion, we would be best served by doing what our thoroughbred brethren do when such horses are not sold — that is, to list the horse as an RNA.

There are a few, including the industry's largest vendor, Preferred Equine Marketing, that do it religiously.

I am just guessing, but I believe the vast majority do not.

Some have even been known to have used non-existent or phantom names to disguise the fact that the horse was a bid in.

Reporting RNAs across the board would serve two purposes.

The first is that the public knows the truthful result of the bidding.

The second is that it allows the consignor and any prospective purchasers to get together on a possible private purchase of said horse or horses.

It becomes a win-win situation.

I understand a breeder, especially a smaller breeder, believing his horse is worth a certain amount to him and when the horse does not bring anywhere near what he or she believes it is worth, deciding to bid it in.

That would be comparable to a person who has a brand new Mercedes selling it for the price of a Buick. It's rare and probably should not happen.

However, with Hanover that was never the case.

The over-riding philosophy has been that what you might lose on the oranges, you are likely to make up for on the apples. If on the rare occasions you didn't, then so be it.

Above all, the feeling was that Hanover feels their reputation is ultra-important. They are not focusing on just one yearling or a small group of yearlings, or even just one year's crop.

They were selling hundreds of them and, perhaps more importantly, expected to be doing so for many years to come. If they sold a good horse too cheap, they felt that buyer would be back. Mr. Simpson would sometimes jokingly phrase it, "You've got to sometimes sell some good horses cheap, in order to sell some cheap horses good."

That is just the nature of the auction process — especially when it applies to yearlings.

One never knows what they are truly worth until they hit the racetrack.

Over the years there have been numerous people who have asked to be able to privately purchase Hanover yearlings, sometimes for more than they would have been expected to bring at auction. The answer has always been a thank you, but an emphatic NO!

The feeling was that it wouldn't serve them well for a customer to lose a horse to a Hanover bred that they did not have a chance to get.

Once again, it is a case of strictly abiding to policy and looking at the entire picture.

They are in it for the long run and value the trust of their customers and hope to do that for many years to come.

It is a tradition that I firmly believed in and defended fiercely in all my years there.

Compensation for use of a horse's name

The decision in California to allow college athletes to be compensated for using their name and image is in my opinion long overdue and well merited.

I am sure other states will follow suit, as they well should. How does this apply to horse racing you might ask?

Several years ago I was involved in a situation where an owner of a horse expressly forbade a farm and the sale from whence the horse came from using that horse's name in advertising without the express written consent of the present owner of the horse.

Silly, you might say? Perhaps.

Nevertheless, the sales company took the threat serious enough to insert a clause in the Conditions of Sale allowing the sales company to use the name and image of any horses that were sold by said company in perpetuity without any recourse. To my knowledge the clause still exists.

Would it stand up in court? I have no idea.

The king is dead, long live the king

The passing of Somebeachsomewhere left a huge void in worldwide pacing that will be felt for generations to come. His influence was dearly seen at the recent Lexington race meet and sale.

His absence was clearly felt and noticed at the sale where he continued to lead all pacing stallions in both dollar amounts and averages received for his yearlings.

Many, myself included, felt that the throne had been passed to his great son Captaintreacherous who leads 2-year-olds in earnings by a very significant margin over his dad in second place.

I felt going into the sale that it was a certainty that CT would lead all pacers in receipts with SBSWs perhaps being relegated to the bargain department.

Not only did I think it. I wrote it. I could not have been more wrong.

Surprisingly, at least to me, as this is written, SBSW leads CT by the very slimmest of margins among 3-year-old earners.

Iconic sire Bettors Delight occupies third place in both categories. That's a truly amazing feat for a stallion, now 22

years old, who is enjoying his finest year ever.

Of prime importance might be the fact that the old guy is number one in the all age category by a significant margin over Somebeachsomewhere who occupies second place.

Don't miss the Pelicans

On a totally non-equine related subject, if you have an interest in basketball and have the opportunity to see the New Orleans Pelicans play, do not miss it.

They will likely not be the best team in the NBA, but without a doubt they will be the most exciting and entertaining.

I watched their first exhibition game against the Atlanta Hawk and they came as advertised. Zion Williamson was his normal inhuman self. In addition they are loaded with other exceptional young talent Lonzo Ball, Jrue Holiday, Brandon Ingram, Josh Hart are just a few. The main thing they may lack is seasoning and maturity. Veteran JJ Redick should supply some of that.

Black Book Two provides rare opportunity

Looking at the Standardbred Horse Sales Company's Black Book Two mixed sale catalogue, if someone is contemplating getting into the breeding business or upping their presence in it, there may never be a better opportunity to do so than at this year's Harrisburg sale.

There are shares or breeding rights to just about every top trotting or pacing stallion in the industry available, some in abundance, especially to the leading trotting stallion Muscle Hill.

I suppose this is because there is an plethora of young, proven or unproven stallions out there whose shares are also to be found available for purchase. They include, but are not necessarily limited to Bar Hopping, Chapter Seven, Devious Man, Father Patrick, International Moni, Royalty For Life, Southwind Frank, Tactical Landing, Trixton and Walner.

The pacers are equally represented at or near the top, but there are not nearly as many of them.

If you are looking for broodmares, the place to start of course is with the White Birch Farms dispersal. The Parisi family has been breeding trotters and pacers for in excess of 60 years through three generations.

Included in this once in a lifetime dispersal are several mares who are already viewed as foundation mares from which breeding empires rise, or several who will undoubtedly reach that status.

If only I were significantly younger and had the means to dive in. This is where I would undoubtedly begin.

Outstanding performance in Germany by Riordan's new star

Swedish trainer Jerry Riordan had never before won a Group 1 race in Germany, but on Sunday afternoon, the talkative and charismatic trainer established another great victory in a European stake race.

Riordan had two weapons in \$165,500 Grosser Preis von Deutschland in Hamburg on Sunday afternoon and when driver Rikard N Skoglund served Varenne son Zarenne Fas a perfect trip in the 1.3-mile race, Riordan could see his 4-year-old playing the game in superior style.

Zarenne Fas was second over and Rikard N Skoglund left that position and attacked three wide in the last turn. Then Zarenne Fas answered by easily sweeping past his opponents and left the field of 13 horses by more than 10 lengths in the home stretch.

The mile rate was 1:56.1 and behind the winner, Maxus (Muscle Hill) finished second ahead of Riordan's second horse in the race, Zabul Fi (Ganymede).

"This is probably the first win in Germany for me overall, so I thought it would be good to win the biggest race as well," Riordan said after the race.

This season has been a successful one for Riordan. Ringostarr Treb (Classic Photo) has won \$305,000 Hugo Åbergs Memorial and \$183,000 Sundsvall Open Trot, while 3-year-old Bold Eagle son Aetos Kronos was outstanding in two \$203,000 E3 races this summer. Aetos Kronos also won a final of \$203,000 Breeders Course at Solvalla during Elitloppet Day in May.

Riordan can look back at 321 starts, 46 victories and purse earnings of \$1,325,538 in 2019.

Zarenne Fas replay.

More stars in the Z-crop in Italy

Zarenne Fas won in Germany, Zacon Gio won the International Trot at Yonkers and Italy seems to bring up several great trotters born in 2015.

On Sunday night, Alessandro Gocciadoro hit the lead and took a safe wire-to-wire triumph with Zaniah Bi (Equinox Bi) in \$169,000 Gran Premio Memorial Giuseppe Biasuzzi in Treviso, Italy.

French trained Fric du Chene was runner up behind the superior winner and Zefiro d'Ete got bronze medal. Zaniah Bi trotted 1:54.4 over the mile.

Cleangame in Toulouse

Jean-Michel Bazire trained Cleangame (Ouragan de Celland) went to Toulouse and contested the \$165,000 Grand Prix du Sud-Ouest on Sunday afternoon and Bazire wasn't a bit worried when he put his 7-year-old gelding in position first over throughout the 1.7-mile long race.

Bazire is just a phenomenon in the bike and he always seems to know exactly what it takes out his horses to win big races. Cleangame is definitely one of the best gelded trotters in the world and most certainly the best in that category in France, since Bazire's star Aubrion du Gers tragically died in a training accident this summer.

This time, Bazire controlled the field and let his horse leave the challengers mid-stretch. The mile rate for Cleangame was 1:59.4 and this was his ninth victory in 2019.
