Next generation sharing in Ontario Super Finalists

Thanks to plans to encourage the next generation of standardbred enthusiasts, young owners of talented Ontario Super Finalists Pemberton and Desperate Man have a major shot in Saturday's \$250,000 finals at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Just before 10 p.m. on Saturday (Oct. 17) there will be an unusual buzz of activity in rural Tara, ON.

The flurry of activity stems from a plot hatched by Paul and Brenda Walker in 2016 when they decided to breed their unraced Muscle Mass-Our Day daughter Dayshifter to Wheeling N Dealin.

"Paul said, 'Why don't we let Christine have a piece of her because she has three kids and it would be a good way to get them interested in the racing, because they are dairy farmers," said Brenda Walker. "So we gave her a piece of the mare — and we didn't know whether she's going to get in foal or throw anything — and between Paul and I we picked Wheeling N Dealin, and to be honest a lot of it was because they were giving away free breedings if we signed up before the end of January. So that's how Pemberton came about."

Dayshifter's first foal, Pemberton has been a standout on the Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) circuit this summer and leads the 3-year-old trotting colts into Saturday's \$250,000 Super Final at Woodbine Mohawk Park where he gets Post 3 in the eighth race. The gelding went three-for-four in Gold Series





action and also captured four overnight wins in nine starts. His Royalty For Life half-brother Harry made four appearances in the Gold Series this summer and logged a pair of third-place finishes, just missing the top 10 in the two-year-old trotting colt division.

And while the horses have been successful, the decision to involve daughter Christine Walker and her children Austin, 14, Kody, 12, and Amelia, 10, in Dayshifter and her progeny has paid off in far more important ways for the family.

"The kids, they're on the computer to watch and now they're getting a little superstitious. They have to watch in the milk house in front of the computer, they have to sit in the same seats while this horse is racing and the boys, especially the oldest boy, Austin, know who is in the race and who is the best one," said Walker. "Amelia, the youngest one, she likes the horses and now that Pemberton made some money for them she actually got a large pony to ride, just a month ago.

"So it has worked, they're quite interested in it and I know Austin is wanting to come with his mother to the races Saturday night. And of course, because they are watching they've got some of the neighbors watching. There's a girlfriend of Christine's, she's got really excited about it, she's watching Pemberton race and we gave her one of the

sweaters that they win. So yeah, it is actually helping that

way to create a little interest with some of their friends and family now."

Last fall, Kathy and John Cecchin also made the decision to share one of their horses with daughter Nicole and son-in-law Paul Davies, offering the couple half of Shadow Play-Dreamlands Latte son Desperate Man as a wedding gift. That decision has also paid off in countless ways for the Arthur, ON residents.

"He has been, really a dream come true. Sharing it with them has been emotional, like I could cry," said a choked-up Kathy Cecchin, who trains the colt. "It wouldn't be the same, I don't think, if it wasn't all of us together.

"It's been really great, and they have the baby and we have some funny pictures with him with the baby and that's been very special," said Cecchin about nine-month-old grandson Deacon. "He's a sweetheart, loves the horses, just absolutely is crazy about the horses, so who knows how that will all pan out."

Like Pemberton, Desperate Man leads the 2-year-old pacing colts into Saturday's Super Final showdown, tallying three wins, one second and one third in his five starts, all in the Gold Series. Trevor Henry will steer both Pemberton and Desperate Man, who gets Post 9 in the fourth race, and Cecchin said the reinsman and his wife, Shannon, are like extended members of the family who have added to the enjoyment of campaigning the colt.

"Trevor and Shannon are stabled here and have been for I think going on nine years now," said Cecchin. "John helps them, they help us. It's a good relationship."


Henry has even subjected Cecchin to some good-natured ribbing through the season as she dealt with the nerves and pressure of training and racing a horse she knew was special well before he ever set foot on the racetrack.

"I worry about him. Not the outcome, just about him, because the outcome is going to be whatever the outcome is going to be, it's him," said the trainer, who is hoping Nicole will be able to join her at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Saturday to help paddock the pacer. "I would always say (to Trevor), 'Good luck' or 'safe trip' or whatever, but the first time he raced at Mohawk I cried and I said, 'Please just keep him safe."


Ashleigh Hensley said her strategy for dealing with the nerves is to keep busy in the paddock and not pay too much attention to the race. Her worry is two-fold as husband Ed Hensley drives most of their horses.

"I try to just keep busy and kind of watch the race as I'm getting the next horse ready, because sometimes I can get a little excited," said Hensley. "It's different for us because we're doing all the work with them all week and it means a lot to us when they go out and race good, and then when they don't perform it's disappointing because it's us that did all the work. It's just lots of ups and downs really."

Hensley should have no trouble keeping busy on Saturday as the couple will send out a trio of 2-year-old Super Final starters. Pacing colt Twin B Fighter (Bettors Delight-In The Pink) will start from

Post 10 in the fourth race while pacing fillies Scarlett Hanover (Bettors Delight– Sammys Magic Girl) and City By The Bay (Bettors Delight–Bay Girl) get Posts 5 and 6 in the seventh race. Hensley's brother Travis Cullen, with whom the couple share a Dundas, ON farm, will steer City By The Bay.

The youngsters are a bit of a departure for the couple, who typically own all of the horses in their small stable and like to keep the balance at half pacers and half trotters. The pacing trio were sent north from the Ron Burke stable in late June and will be heading back down south on Sunday morning.

"On Sunday they're all going to Lexington," said Hensley. "It will be a sad day, they've become part of our family here, part of our team, and they've done well and we've enjoyed having them."

Hensley is grateful for the opportunity to train the youngsters, something she and Ed hope to do more of in future. They have two broodmares of their own, one pacer and one trotter, and hope to find a yearling or two that fit their budget this fall.

Cecchin and Walker are also grateful for the success they have enjoyed this season and look forward to sharing harness racing's ups and downs with their families for years to come.

"We feel really very blessed that we got to race this year

because there was a while there that I certainly didn't think that it was written in stone that we were even going to get to race," said Cecchin, who recently increased the size of her barn so Nicole and Paul can move their horses onto the farm. "I think that that part alone has been a gift."

"It's been a pretty good year for us and we're happy, thankful for everything," said Walker.

The \$2 million Ontario Sires Stakes Super Finals go postward at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Saturday, Oct. 17. The eight \$250,000 finals are slated for Races 1 through 4 and 6 through 9. **Programs** and a **live stream** are available on the racetrack's **website**.






Lampman Cup achievement significant to McClure

Bob McClure will steer several favorites in Saturday's (Oct. 17) \$2 million Super Finals at Woodbine Mohawk Park, but even before the starting gate swings open for the first final the Rockwood, ON resident has achieved a goal that has been in his sights since his Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) driving debut.

Driver Bob McClure has won his first Lampman Cup as the top driver in the Ontario Sires Stakes program.

After a back and forth battle with five-time champion Sylvain Filion, McClure has locked up his first Lampman Cup title as the leading driver in the OSS program, helped along by a trio of Gold Series victories late last week with Super Final mounts Macho Martini, Threefiftytwo and Tattoo Artist.

"I don't know what drew me about it, but I always wanted to win it," said McClure, who has kept an eye on the Lampman Cup point standings since he started appearing regularly in OSS winner's circles five years ago. "It's pretty tough to win. Sylvain (Filion) is very dedicated to the OSS program and he's a great driver, and you look at Trevor Henry with the accounts he drives for, they have a lot of stake horses, and then with Doug (McNair) and his dad having a big stable of OSS horses, it's kind of tough to compete with them. I think you kind of need a year where everything just falls into place for you and that's exactly what happened this year. When I found out the other night that I kind of sealed it up I was pretty proud of that, because I have so much respect for Sylvain Filion as a driver."

Established in 1987 in memory of long time Ontario Jockey Club harness racing publicist Jim Lampman, the Lampman Cup has been won by some of the province's top reinsmen but the driver that sparked McClure's interest in the title is one whose name is not listed among the winners, his uncle Jim McClure.

"He mentioned something to me when I was first starting out, and he never talked about awards much, but he did mention that (Lampman Cup) and he said that was something he always wanted to win," recalled McClure, who launched his driving career in 2009. "He drove for a lot of the OSS trainers so I'm sure he was always up there, but he did mention that he always wished that he'd had a chance to win, so it's nice that I got to win it for my family."

McClure has been a contender for the award for the past three years, helped along by his association with trainer Luc Blais and owner Determination's powerful stable of trotters. The driver will steer a trio of Blais trainees on Saturday's rich Super Final program starting with 2-year-old trotting filly Dicentra from Post 1 in the first final, followed by 2-year-old trotting colt division point leader Macho Martini from Post 5 in the fifth \$250,000 showdown and wrapping up with 3-year-old trotting colt Threefiftytwo from Post 10 in the seventh of eight finals.

"They come with such a powerhouse stable, and a lot of them are Ontario Sired, so that right there gives me a big boost in the OSS ranks. Other drivers are trying to find a top OSS trotter, where you know my situation, between Threefiftytwo, Dicentra, Macho Martini, mine are just there and they're highly competitive," said McClure. "If you don't have the horses in front of you, you might as well be pushing a rope."

In addition to the trio of trotters, McClure will also wrap up the 2020 OSS season behind 3-year-old pacing filly division point leader Lauras Love, who gets Post 3 in the second final, 2-year-old pacing colt Lawless Shadow, who will start from Post 3 in the fourth battle, 2-year-old pacing filly Alumni Seelster from Post 4 in the sixth final and 3-year-old pacing colt division point leader Tattoo Artist from the outside Post 9 in the finale.

"I feel very fortunate that I got to drive horses like Tattoo Artist and Macho Martini and Lawless Shadow and Lauras Love. It's not very often you can string together five, six horses with such a serious chance going into the Super Final," said McClure. "I can name six right now that have a very strong chance at winning the Super Final and it's not very often a driver is lucky enough to get that in one year, so I feel very fortunate."

Once the Super Final wraps up McClure plans to spend the next four weeks plying his trade south of the border, which may prevent him from accomplishing another item on his career bucket list.

"I don't think it's going to happen this year, but I would like to win a driving title at Woodbine (Mohawk Park) one day. I wouldn't say it's a big priority for me, it would just be nice. It would be like a feather in the cap," said the driver. "I think I have the lead right now and I still don't think it will be possible to win it this year, just because my big accounts are about to go dormant for the winter and I'm about to do some travelling for the Breeders Crown, Fall Four, etcetera, and so I'm going to be away for some time, but if there was one bucket list (item) I would say that's probably it."

Heading into the Super Final McClure had piloted 199 starters in OSS action this summer, recording 44 wins, 26 seconds and 30 thirds for earnings of \$1,860,669 and a Lampman Cup point total of 513, 34 points ahead of Sylvain Filion. Through the 2020 Woodbine Mohawk Park season he boasts 1,061 starts for 182 wins, 141 seconds, 136 thirds and earnings of \$5,323,882, 11 wins ahead of Filion. Both men will steer seven horses in Super Final action on Saturday.

The \$250,000 Super Finals, which feature the top 10 point earners from the Gold Series regular season, will go postward in Races 1 through 4 and 6 through 9 on Woodbine Mohawk Park's Saturday, Oct. 17 program. All the excitement gets under way at 7 pm.

Although on-track attendance is limited to registered guests, fans can download a **program** and watch the **live stream** on the Woodbine Mohawk Park **website**.

Questions from a small breeder, thoughts on auctioneers that drive up prices and do the same five owners really win all the stakes?

Tidbits: It's a credit to the resilience of our industry, the amazing success of the Lexington Experience in 2020, the year of the pandemic. The funeral the naysayers predicted turned into a wedding. The sale was terrific and the racing fabulous.

The turnout was so good that if, like me, you came during the first race any one of the days you had to wait for a parking space. We even got lucky with the weather. Although not ideal, it was far better than the expected monsoon.

If I could find any fault at all I would say the track itself was way too hard and compromised any trotter with aches and pains. That said it is nobody's fault. With heavy rains in the forecast the track crew had no choice. The razor sharp racing strip resulted in many new track and world records.

I have often discussed the possibility of returning to heat racing for the Hambletonian and the Kentucky Futurity and John Campbell had me convinced otherwise mainly because of the difference in the body type of the horse we are breeding today. John was right, but not necessarily in regard

to heat racing but in regard to the more brittle nature of our sleeker equines.

It was evident to this writer after watching all the Red Mile races this year, a year that because of the virus horses raced way less than they normally would, that many of the new breed we are working with are visibly tired, sore, and over raced.

The strangest fact in all this is that the horses to which I am referring like Reflect With Me, Ramona Hill, and Ready For Moni, all have one thing in common, they have been more than judiciously raced all with fewer than 10 starts to date. That begs the question, how many races is too many? Obviously that is determined by each individual horse, but I have no clue as to where to start to figure out that answer.

Let's just hope that the super hard racetrack is the demon that did them in and they will all bounce back in the weeks to come.

* * *

No horse should start in the second tier in a major stakes race. Some of my learned friends have suggested, and rightly so, that we have 10 horses behind the gate and put up a decent amount of cash for a consolation. BRILLIANT.

There are other reasons for not utilizing a second tier, other than the obvious unfairness for the compromised starting spot. One, as witnessed by the reaction of Ready For Moni who was totally confused following another horse to the gate in the Futurity and another that was not evident in this past Sunday's racing but I have witnessed many times before is that when the horse on the gate has an open bridle and sees a horse following behind the gate some will freak out and run because it is a new and different situation than they are used too.

* * *

Back again to heat racing. I understand that the logistics no longer work and it affords major problems to television coverage — not that there is any for the Kentucky Futurity. I also understand the difficulty on the betting angle with no preprinted program. That said, not just I, but many, miss it.

We need something new and if going back to heat racing doesn't work, varied distances may do the job. Change and fresh is good and will most likely have a positive effect on our attendance and handle.

While on the subject of the Kentucky Futurity, congratulations to the owners of Amigo Volo the Pinske Stable and a special guy David J Miller as well as Nifty Norman and Dexter Dunn the trainer and driver of the winner. Not an easy race to win at this point in the season,

job well done.

I haven't seen a winner's circle photo in a long time that made me smile more than the photo of Julie and Andy Miller on the Futurity chair after their win in the Filly Futurity. PRICELESS.

Best of luck to all those that took home my draft selections in the Kentucky Selected Sale especially Nancy Takter and my \$27,000 Cantab Hall colt selection. Hopefully I can say next year "I told you so."

Craig Gordon asks: Do you think it's good for the game that the same five owners and trainers win every race at the Red Mile? Last year was supposed to be the greatest yearling sale ever, how come so few show up at the races?

It matters not what trainers or owners win races at any venue. The quality and competitiveness of the racing is what is important. However, before you make a comment you should check your facts.

The major stakes last weekend at the Red Mile were won by Bret Pelling, Ake Svanstedt, Nifty Norman, Marie Ortolan Bar, Mark Harder, Noel Daley, Nancy Takter, Marcus Melander, Joe Holloway, Ron Burke, Jim King Jr., Chris Ryder, and Julie Miller,

That number would be 13 not 5.

As for owners, not five but 47 individual owners were involved in sharing the winning purses this past weekend at the Red Mile.

As for the performance of last year's yearling crop, the price of a colt does not determine success or failure on the racetrack. I am not making excuses for the buyers or trainers, yet 2020 was anything but a normal year and I am certain that there were many changes in scheduling and training as well as a myriad of other problems that had a deleterious effect on many horses this year.

Next time, make an attempt at asking a question with a little less negativity. It would serve you well.

Dr Brett Anderson asks: I am a small breeder and have these questions. 1. What are your thoughts on breeding well-bred mares that were no good on the racetrack? 2. Thoughts on breeding mares that have size, conformation and good race record with no pedigree? 3. Thoughts on breeding mares by off stallions like Glidemaster or Muscle Massive.

Maybe you asked the wrong person the first question because with trotters I am jaded. I have trained seven world champion mares including the likes of Continentalvictory, Beat The Wheel and Imperfection that have never had a top horse. Beat The Wheel has had a good filly but "Connie" and Imperfection from about 16 foals didn't have a horse that could beat me. On the other hand, Continentalvictory herself came from Intercontinental a mare that Jan Johnson trained and he told me she had no ability at all.

Harness Racing Update

There is no definitive answer. However, I will say that I am far more likely to buy a pacer from a fast mare than a trotter.

In my last few years training, I raced the dams of two top horses — Manchego and Six Pack — and neither was a great race mare but both had gait and pedigree. Manchego's dam was on the small size and Six Packs' was huge.

Basically I like well-bred mares with no or milder records especially daughters of great mares.

In answer to mares with little pedigree and good conformation and performance, I would shy away. That said, pedigree is a matter of taste and is not universal by any means. There are times that what one would witness a poorly-bred mare create her own popular family. I bought Vernon Blue Chip for \$17,000 and a few foals later the family was commanding six figures and she herself was a top producer. Singular cases as that should not influence your thinking. When you are breeding for the public, the power of the page will attract customers to the stall. Basically at major sales venues there are few pages with what you would call a bad pedigree.

As for question number 3. There is no such thing as an off stallion when it comes to dam sires. Continental victory is from a Chiola Hanover mare, not exactly a household name. The family is what the public is looking for not the dam sire.

In my own personal preferences when it comes to trotters there are some dam sires that make me think twice because to me they breed unsoundness into the equation, but they are few and far between and represent way less than one per cent of the yearlings I have looked at.

To quote Myron Bell, there are no crosses in harness racing. You want crosses go to a church.

Joel Kravet asks: Do you think it is right for the consignor to have the auctioneer drive up the price on a yearling? Shouldn't they announce a reserve?

If it's not broken don't try to fix it. Nothing has changed in my 60 years in the business.

Put yourself in the seller's position. This is not a game it's a business to almost all consignors and agents. They want to get the most they possibly can for their product. The psychology of a live auction is that it creates excitement and in the spur of the moment, as the bidding rises, you are way more likely to spend more than you wanted to before the sale commenced. There is no reason you can give me that would diminish my feeling that an owner has every right to protect his horse to a price he thinks is fair.

If there were predetermined reserves that were announced prior to the sale it would deter many bidders from bothering to even be present no less bid when the hip number entered the ring. It would lessen the rhythm of the auction and slow the excitement to a walk.

At any auction the amount of live bids is directly proportionate to the gross of the sale.



Indiana Super Finals kick off monster stretch of racing at Hoosier Park

In a season that's completely flown since its restart in June, Breeders Crown elimination races at Hoosier Park loom just one week away. But first, Indiana-sired 2 and 3-year-olds will have a chance to shine over the course of eight \$270,000 Super Finals tonight totaling over \$2.1 million in purses.

Race 3 — ISS Super Final 2YOFP

Throughout the sire stake final races, an overriding theme is the value that these Indiana-sired horses provide. Not only were many competitors throughout the finals modestly priced yearlings, but young horses from the state have proven they're good enough to go with open stakes competition too. An example comes in the form of race favorite SOMETHINGBEAUTIFUL. A \$30,000 Hoosier sale yearling, she's a half-sibling to over \$750,000 career earner Shnitzledosomethin. Perfect in Indiana-restricted competition, Somethingbeautiful's only loss came two back in the Kentuckiana when she was second to the standout Test Of Faith. She goes from regular driver Lewayne Miller to Tim Tetrick and will be tough to beat despite starting from the outside post. HOT MESS EXPRESS gets her fifth crack at Somethingbeautiful and is another that gets a noticeable driver change; this one to Andy Miller. SOMETHING TO ME was a 1:51.4 winner two back and gamely chased home Somethingbeautiful last out after picking up her cover around the final turn. GD ROCKIN KAY tried to rally up the inside last and can close to land a share. JK SHE'S GORGEOUS may be better served to change tactics and come from off the pace; I doubt she can beat last against these on the lead.

Race 4 — ISS Super Final 2YOCT

Maybe easy to say now but it's still hard to believe that

BRECKENRIDGE paid \$13 last week considering he had won three straight ISS races prior – and all at shorter prices than last weeks. In that race last week. Shetler wanted the lead from the start and he was proved right when gaining the tactical edge throughout the race and holding off a late charge; exits a lifetime best mile. BROOKVIEW BOLT was rallying late up the inside last out and seemed to flatten just a touch after looking like he was en route to getting up. That was the second time in three races he was closing but not quick enough against Breckenridge; good matchup coming again. ILLINI EARL looked like a winner against these four races back after taking the lead in the stretch only to then tire. He's since won twice and then closed last out with some enthusiasm. SWINGFORTHEFENCES wasn't far off Brookview Bolt on a couple prior occasions and then was able to tow along last out to produce a fast time in Lexington. BRIDGE TO SUCCESS rates an outside chance.

Race 8 — ISS Super Final 3YOFP

GRACE ROCKS enters her Super Final for 3-year-old fillies in raging form and has turned into quite a killer over her last few starts. After posting back to back 1:49.2 and 1:49.4 miles, she won last out under total wraps while all others chased futilely. Will warrant a short price despite starting from the outside post 9. SOMEBODYSLILLY took a first over shot last out against Grace Rocks but you never got the impression she was going to get close and then tired in the stretch. She was much better two back and would need to bring her very best to compete for the top spot. GENIE ROCKWELL went a 1:49 mile three back but then was no match whatsoever for Grace Rocks when she gave way from the pocket. She did rebound however in her most recent and is another that can't afford anything less than her best. MYSTICAL CARRIE did okay last week when she tipped wide from last to just get up to be second in a blanket finish. PRICELESS didn't have much to offer in her last few but took a good amount of tote action last out against Grace Rocks, discount connections at your own peril.

Race 9 — ISS Super Final 2YOFT

COUNTRY GIRL CHARM costs just \$6,000 as a yearling last year at the Hoosier sale and responded powerfully to racing first time with Lasix; albeit it came in a race where everything broke her way. From the second crop of sire Whom Shall I Fear, she has speed to overcome the post and is dangerous if that good again. SHIRLEY GOODNESS couldn't be any more consistent having posted four straight miles and all in the 1:55 range; fastest on paper and is the one to beat. SWIFT SWANDA is suddenly a much tougher call.

Harness Racing Update

Any number of her previous miles would be good enough to compete, but she looked empty last week even before the break. At least offers a price now. BAD SHOT and FOUR UNDER PAR starting next to each other in posts 5 and 6 amuses me; doesn't seem like their names go together and both would need to go a couple steps quicker than they've gone before.

Race 11 - ISS Super Final 3YOFT

MAY BABY was one that I liked in the Hambletonian Oaks when she came off that first-over try the week prior against Hypnotic Am. The trip just didn't work out at all for her in that race and she's been utterly dominant since; would take something unforeseen for her to lose. ROCK SWAN actually beat the top choice once back in August but was gapped out every step against that same rival last week, and PHABAJ was about equally a gapped out third in that same race. PRETZEL PARY is a longshot that might be able to save ground from the second tier and then try to close; has shown flashes of potential on occasion. QUEEN MARGHERITA closed to score last out; WOODSIDE DATENDIVA rallied to be second to that foe and out-closed her by nearly a full second.

Race 12 — ISS Super Final 2YOCP

JK GOING WEST is another inexpensive yearling with a chance to take home a big purse. Having cost just \$12,000 at the Michiana Classic Yearling Sale, he was ultra-impressive last out. He left hard into a :26.2 opening guarter and was forced early to have to settle for third. Despite the trip he was able to out-finish VIRGO who popped pocket after getting the two-hole trip to win in a career best 1:51. BROOKVIEW BULLET didn't have much resistance to offer in the stretch last out and that was a surprise. That had been his first start in three weeks and he was awesome prior to then; another tough call. WHAT'S YOUR BEEF took advantage of a softer field last out and won easy as the heavy favorite; maybe a play-against despite going for Brian Brown if the price is too short. HE'S GONNA GETYA had some late pace to offer up the inside in his most recent race; would be quite a spot to break the maiden. ROGERS IMAGE made a belated surge in his most recent; wouldn't be a total shock.

Race 13 — ISS Super Final 3YOCT

It didn't look like Oosting had to move a muscle last week on EMMA TOWN BUD in posting the easiest type of score. It's too bad the gelding by Big Stick Lindy broke in the Old Oaken Bucket at Delaware but he'll make amends here. Conversely to the top choice, BLUEBIRD DEACON was under an all-out drive last week and couldn't do anything against that foe. SWAN IN MOTION was favored against Emma Town Bud in August but probably shouldn't have been; I didn't think he was particularly great last week in his first start from the layoff. DUDE INCLUDED had good trot on both ends of his mile two back.

Race 14 — ISS Super Final 3YOCP

The star of the night could be ODDS ON OSIRIS. Milstein winner from August didn't disgrace himself in the North America Cup and then crushed last week in 1:49.3 and with broken equipment no less. CLEVER CHARACTER was a first-over winner in his most recent and prior he angled out in the stretch and took a mild chance against the likes of No Lou Zing. SAWYER'S DESIRE got somewhat of a shuffle last out after brushing to the lead; had some minor late pace to get up for second but would have never gotten to the big favorite regardless. CROOK BOYZZ arrived late on the scene last week and prior to that tried to give Odds On Osiris a run.

Odds On Osiris (Peter Wrenn) will try to repeat as an Indiana Sire Stakes (ISS) champion tonight (Oct. 16) at Harrah's Hoosier Park.

Indiana's best prepare for Sire Stakes finals, then Breeders Crown

Odds On Osiris will try to repeat as an Indiana Sire Stakes (ISS) champion tonight (Oct. 16) at Harrah's Hoosier Park, where success could propel him to the Breeders Crown a week later when the event returns to Hoosier for the second time in four years.

A multiple Grand Circuit stakes winner in his career, Odds On Osiris topped this season's Indiana Sire Stakes standings for 3-year-old male pacers thanks to three wins and two seconds in the series. He heads to the final off back-to-back ISS victories, including a career-best 1:49.3 score last week at Hoosier. It was his first race since Sept. 18.

"I thought he felt pretty good," driver Peter Wrenn said. "He handled that pretty easily. But it's racing and (tonight) is not going to be easy. Hopefully, the end result is good. He's a very nice horse. If everything goes right, he's got this week and if he comes out of it all right, we've got the Breeders Crown.

"The only problem is I don't have enough of them (like him)," he added, laughing. "Other than that, everything is perfect."

Odds On Osiris has won four of eight races this year and earned \$249,780. He won the Carl Milstein Memorial in August and has been off the board only once, when started in the second tier and was fourth in the North America Cup final despite a :26.3 final quarter that was at least four-fifths of a second faster than the horses that finished ahead of him.

"I thought he raced really well up there," said Wrenn, who watched Sylvain Filion drive the gelding in Canada because of international travel restrictions related to the COVID-19

pandemic. "He was charging at the end. That's just part of racing."

For his career, Odds On Osiris has won 11 of 18 races and \$593,675. He is trained by Wrenn's wife, Melanie.

"It's quite a transition from (age) 2 to 3 and not all horses step up to the plate," Peter said. "He did. I couldn't be any happier with him."

Another horse looking to repeat as an Indiana Sire Stakes champion is 3-year-old female trotter Rock Swan. The Erv Miller-trained filly has won five of 10 races this season and hit the board in every start despite battling foot issues. She competed in all seven preliminary legs of the sire stakes, posting four victories and three seconds.

For her career, she has won 14 of 21 races and been worse than second only once.

"We've been playing with her shoes to get her a little better and hopefully she'll be on key," Miller said. "She trained really nice (Tuesday) morning. Hopefully, she'll be good to go on Friday night and then move on to the Breeders Crown. She's got May Baby to beat and she hasn't beaten her in their last couple starts. Hopefully, she'll be a little better Friday."

May Baby, a Breeders Crown finalist in 2019 after finishing second to Rock Swan in the Indiana championship, has won six of nine races this year and brings a three-race win streak

to Friday's start. She equaled the Hoosier Park track record for a 3-year-old trotting filly, 1:52.2, in her most recent triumph.

"She's in top form," said James Yoder, who trains and drives the filly. "Hopefully, she will stay like that for the next several weeks. Three more weeks like that would be OK with me.

"I've been pretty happy with her year. We had some foot issues (in August) and it took a few weeks to figure it out. It's been smooth sailing since then."

Yoder also hopes to send Katkin American, an Indiana Sire Stakes finalist in the event for older male trotters, to the Breeders Crown. The 5-year-old gelding, a Hoosier track-record-setter at 3 who missed his entire 4-year-old season, has been lightly raced due to injuries. He has 11 wins and eight seconds in 20 career starts.

"We've been aiming him for October," Yoder said. "We've been aiming for it all year."

Miller, too, has additional Breeders Crown hopefuls, including Swift Swanda. She has won five of nine races this year and topped the ISS standings for 2-year-old female trotters.

"She's a big, strong filly," Miller said. "She's just a little immature still this year. She just needs to mature. I think she'll make a great 3-year-old."

Other Indiana Sire Stakes finalists eligible to the Breeders Crown include 2-year-old male pacers JK Going West, Brookview Bullet, and Virgo; 2-year-old female pacer Somethingbeautiful; 2-year-old male trotter Brookview Bolt; 3-year-old female pacer Priceless; 3-year-old male trotters Swan In Motion and Emma Town Bud; older female trotters Compelling, Custom Cantab, and Grand Swan; older female pacer Rockin Nola; older male trotters Bridge To Jesse's,

Fiftydallarbill, and It's A Herbie; and older male pacer Little Rocket Man.

Fiftydallarbill was a Breeders Crown champion at age 2, in 2017 at Hoosier Park. He was one of three Indiana stars, with Hannelore Hanover and Beckhams Z Tam, to win a Breeders Crown that year at Hoosier.

This year's Breeders Crown eliminations will be Oct. 23 and Oct. 24. The finals for 2-year-olds will be Oct. 30 and the remaining finals will be Oct. 31.

"I think there will be a lot more local trainers enter this year than the first time (the Breeders Crown) was here," Yoder said. "I think a lot of them noticed how good the Indiana-breds did the first time and I think a lot more nominated into it this year knowing it was going to be at Hoosier again."

Buckeye Classic Yearling Sale average up nearly 53 per cent

Hoosier Classic Sale Company, LLC held its annual Buckeye Classic Yearling Sale Tuesday (Oct. 13), with the event posting a near 53-per cent increase over the 2019 edition. Held at the Champions Center Expo in Springfield, OH, the sale offered a catalog of 212 yearlings, bolstered by a 15-horse Emerald Highlands Farm consignment featuring babies from the first crop of Fear The Dragon. Despite 17 outs, a group of 195 yearlings was sold for a gross of just over \$2.5 million and an average of \$12,904, up from \$8,435 averaged last year.

"It was a strong sale," said sale manager Steve Cross of the company's sixth annual event. "There is a lot of excitement about the Ohio program. We saw that at the Friday session in Lexington, last month in Circleville, and today the first crop of Fear The Dragon was well received."

Fear The Dragon topped the sale sheets, with progeny from the North America Cup and Adios winner garnering seven of the top eight bids, led by Fear My Britches, hammered down for \$100,000. Cataloged as Hip 189 by Emerald Highlands, the colt is out of Soggy Britches and is a half-brother to Breeders Crown champion and Dan Patch Award winner Blazin Britches. Virgil Morgan Jr. purchased Fear My Britches acting as agent for Dana Parham.

The four top-selling yearlings came from the Emerald Highlands consignment. Following Fear My Britches at the top of the session was filly Fear The Britches as Hip 32. An embryo transfer and first foal from Blazin Britches, the Kentucky and Ohio eligible baby brought \$80,000 early in the day, also purchased by Morgan as agent for Parham. Morgan also signed the slip on Hip 133, Fearless Moe, and this time as agent for Carl Howard and Enviro Stable. Out of Rocknroll Hanover mare Maureen Rocks, producer of three winners from four foals, the colt brought \$55,000. Gazitarena, embryo transfer and first foal from Indiana Sires Stakes final winner Rockin Serena, was hammered down for \$45,000. All told, 19 yearlings from the first crop of Fear The Dragon averaged just under \$29,500.

"The whole year was experimental because of COVID. I'm in

the newspaper business and the pandemic has just hurt my business terrible, so we're not going to train as many," said Bruce Trogdon, the man behind Emerald Highlands Farm and owner of Fear The Dragon. "We ended up selling a lot more than we usually do. This is the first crop of Fear The Dragon, we broke 13 yearlings, and every one of them is pacing free-legged on their videos. They really broke well. The colt that brought \$100,000 is the most like Fear The Dragon of any horse I had. He reminded me of him, jogged like him. He's really a nice horse."

Longshot, cataloged as Hip 61, was the top selling trotter in Tuesday's sale. Consigned by Perry Coblentz, the Long Tom colt is a sibling to three previous winners. His dam, Tintern, is a sister to Breeders Crown elimination winner No Pan No Gain, dam of double millionaire Crazy Wow. Wayne Mast Jr. signed the ticket for \$39,000. A group of 16 yearlings sired by Long Tom passed through the ring Tuesday, bringing an average of just shy of \$12,000.

A quartet from the first crop of highly-anticipated Downbytheseaside were consigned to the Buckeye Classic sale, averaging \$20,000. Hip 72, Tin Cup Whiskey, fetched the top bid from the group, sold for \$23,000. Consigned by Cool Winds Farm, the sister to 31-time winner McDazzle was purchased by Kirk Nichols.

Parham spent the most of any buyer, with Morgan signing four tickets for the Boca Raton resident. The purchases totaled \$236,000. Four horses were sold online via Proxibid.

Set for tonight's European Derby

European bred 4-year-olds will meet on the black track of Vincennes over the distance 2,100 meters in \$470,000 Grand Prix de l'U.E.T. tonight (Oct. 16).

Qualifications at Solvalla and Vincennes have resulted in a field of 12 well-merited trotters that chase the big trophy in Paris and it looks like phenomenon Ecurie D. (Infinitif), trained in Norway by Frode Hamre, will be the favorite in the race.

But there are several tough opponents that came to Paris with impressive resumes and, basically, the best 4-year-olds in Europe are there.

Two other Group 1 races are scheduled on tonight's card in Paris. The \$117,500 European Championships for 3-, and 5-year-olds will be held and French star Helgafell (Charly du Noyer) will face 11 opponents in the race for 3-year-olds.

Only nine trotters will be gathered behind the car in the 5-year-old race and it's an open story with Philippe Allaire's Feliciano (Ready Cash) the most merited horse ahead of the race since champion Face Time Bourbon (Ready Cash) will be aimed for Italy and \$775,000 Gran Premio della Lotteria in Naples on Oct. 25.

Face Time Bourbon is obviously the great name for all European tracks on the Grand Circuit calendar for 2021, but it seems like Sébastien Guarato and the owners now have decided that Elitloppet will be held without the greatest trotter in Europe next year. It's too early to tell if this will be the truth when May arrives, but according to the horse's entourage, Face Time Bourbon will have problems combining his stud work with racing during the spring of 2021.

Ohio Sires Stakes action this weekend at Dayton, Northfield

The Ohio Sires Stakes (OHSS) wraps up the 2020 season this weekend with a quartet of \$85,000 events for older horses on Friday, Oct. 16 at Dayton Raceway and an octet of \$75,000 consolation dashes featuring 2- and 3-year-olds of both gaits and genders on Saturday, Oct. 17 at Northfield Park.

At Dayton, 14 veteran mares will line up behind the gate in a pair of seven-horse fields — one trot (Race 6) and one pace (Race 8). As well, 18 veteran horses and geldings will start in a pair of nine-horse splits: a trot (Race 10) and pace (Race 12). Post time at Dayton is 6:15 pm, ET.

The two standouts in the OHSS Veteran Mare Trot are **Pure Chance** and **A TC Queenie**. Both mares have earned more than \$400,000 lifetime and both are sired by Triumphant Caviar. Pure Chance is conditioned and co-owned by Chris Beaver for Steve Zeehandelar, while Ron Steck trains A TC Queenie for Trish Soulsby and Rick Schaut.

Two 6-year-old mares, **Big Bad Jane** and **Rosemary Rose** headline the OHSS Veteran Mares Pace for trainers Christi Noble (the former) and Ronnie Burke (the latter). Big Bad Jane is a \$406,184-earning daughter of Big Bad John who was bred by Sam Noble and owner Sandra Burnett, while Rosemary Rose is a daughter of Foreclosure N who was bred by Ron Salcedo and is owned by the partnership of Burke Racing, J Mellilo and Weaver Bruscemi. Both mares have consistently plied their wares in the open and high conditioned ranks.

The OHSS Veteran Trot features starters who have combined total earnings of \$2,250,352, with the richest diagonally gaited equine being former OHSS Champion **Lane Of Stone**. Trained by Mark Winters for breeder/owner Harry Horowitz, the 4-year-old son of the exported Wishing Stone has lifetime earnings of \$471,182, making him the richest trotter in the field of nine.

Harold Bauder's **Sectionline Bigry** heads up the OHSS Veteran Pace. The 5-year-old homebred Pet Rock gelding has amassed \$522,777 in his career for trainer Steve Bauder via 26 wins, 11 seconds and 10 thirds in 63 lifetime starts. He owns a record of 1:48.1 taken at Hoosier Park in that track's \$35,000 Invitational on Sept. 25 of this year.

Post time at Northfield Park for the OHSS consolations is 6 pm, ET on Saturday evening.

Stickler Hanover, Dream Dancing repeat as PA fairs champs; Miller-Schadel team for 3 titles

Stickler Hanover and **Dream Dancing** repeated as Pennsylvania Fairs champions, and the unlikely duo of Andy Miller and trainer Todd Schadel teamed up for three crowns Monday (Oct. 12) at The Meadows.

The Meadows played host to all eight fairs finals with a number of horsepeople enjoying big days. Brady Brown collected a pair of titles, as did Chris Shaw — both for trainer Mitchell York. Rick Beinhauer also reeled in two championships — one as owner/trainer, the other as owner.

Stickler Hanover was the picture of talent and versatility this year, succeeding at the fairs and in raceway overnights and stakes. On Monday, he zipped to the lead from post 6 for Brown and prevailed over Focus Pocus by a length in 1:56.3, with Manofmanymuscles fourth-placed third. The 3-year-old colt trotter, a son of Explosive Matter-Secret Credit, lifted his career earnings to \$135,765 for trainer Steve Schoeffel and owners Virginia Schoeffel and Kathy Schoeffel.

"One more start, the Simpson, and then he's done for the year," the trainer said. "We'll turn him out for a couple months, then hopefully he'll be my Open horse."

Dream Dancing needed the Lightning Lane to do it, but she edged the 1-9 favorite, Ginger Tree Carey, by a head in a career-best 1:53.1 for Shaw and York. Artistic Spirit completed the ticket.

"She can start and she can finish," said York, who co-owns the 3-year-old daughter of A Rocknroll Dance-Clearly Foxy with David Brickell. "She's good pretty much anywhere on the track. We'll probably race her a few more times this year."

Dream Dancing, who dead-heated for last year's championship win with Silly But Serious, increased her

lifetime bankroll to \$116,700. Interestingly, Silly But Serious also was in Monday's field but couldn't overcome post 9 and finished out of the money.

2-Year-Old Colt & Gelding Trot — Top Me Off

How does a top Grand Circuit driver like Miller end up at the PA Fairs?

"I've never been here for the fairs finals," Miller explained, "but Todd had a lot in and said he needed a little help."

And help Miller did. He steered Top Me Off to a 6-1/2-length blowout in 1:56.3, a life mark. Killer Instinct and By A Hoff Hanover rounded out the ticket.

"In the first quarter, I didn't rush him too much," Miller said of the Bar Hopping—Chiptomylou gelding who races for Todd Schadel, Christine Schadel, Rick Beinhauer and Regina Beinhauer. "Once I got to the front, it was just a little cruise around there after that."

2-Year-Old Colt & Gelding Pace — Terry A Hanover

Terry A Hanover had lost four straight races to Seth Hanover, but he nailed him Monday with the pocket trip Miller worked out, defeating his archrival by 1/2 length in 1:55.2. Shakealeg Hanover, also conditioned by Todd Schadel, was third.

"When I put Andy up, I thought today would be the day," Schadel said.

Christine Schadel and Caitlin Solt campaign the son of Artspeak—Triplet Hanover.

3-Year-Old Colt & Gelding Pace — Nome Hanover

Nome Hanover finished in the money in 16 or his previous 18 starts this year, so it was no surprise when he outkicked Full Send to defeat him by 2-3/4 lengths in a career-fastest 1:52.4 and complete the Miller-Schadel hat trick. Needham Hanover rallied for show.

"I parked him the whole mile at Bloomsburg, and he didn't care," Schadel said of the Well Said—Northern Cameo gelding he owns with Timothy Hayes and Megan Moschgat. "He just keeps going."

2-Year-Old Filly Trot — Explosive Flower

Explosive Flower and Brown provided the day's tote board pyrotechnics, rallying from well back to prevail in 2:00.1 at a juicy 28-1. Sunshineintherain recovered from an early break to finish second, 1/2 length back, with Frankkiss third.

"This filly's been tough all year — she raced super," said winning trainer Beinhauer, who owns the daughter of Explosive Matte—Seeuinthespring with Regina Beinhauer. "She's controllable, very easy to rate and sound."

2-Year-Old Filly Pace — Tiamogonedancen

The daughter of A Rocknroll Dance—Tiamo danced smartly to the top and scored by 3-1/4 lengths in 1:55.3, a lifetime mark, for Shaw and York. Mountain Peaks and Catie Faye Hanover were second and third respectively.

"She had an injury early in the year, so she missed the first three or four fairs," York said of the filly he owns with Brickell. "But she came on strong when she came back. She'll get a couple months off now."
