Second coming?

It's much too early to anoint Beach Glass as the next Somebeach somewhere, but a prodigious start and a story as compelling as that of his famous father — for the same Maritime connections — has many hoping the colt from the late stallion's final crop is the real deal.

Brent MacGrath has said more than once that having another horse as talented as Somebeachsomewhere would flat out never happen. It was the main reason he didn't take his share of Beach's riches and go nuts buying 30 more horses to try for a massively improbable repeat.

There would never be another Somebeachsomewhere – at least not for him.

Friday (Oct. 15), the day after his 2-year-old colt Beach Glass prepped for the Breeders Crown with a jaw-dropping overnight at Woodbine Mohawk Park in which he destroyed a field of 3-year-olds by nine-and-a-quarter lengths in 1:51.1 (replay here), MacGrath held firm that the odds were "not great" that he has another horse the calibre of Somebeachsomewhere, who set a 1:46.4 world record, was 20-for-21 on the track and earned over \$3.2 million en route to multiple Hall of Fame honors.

Still, the man that trained and co-owned Somebeachsomewhere can clearly see what most of us see — the eerie similarities between the two horses and their backstories.

"It's funny that when Beach was coming up through the ranks we were talking about, 'What if? What if? What if?' and now, all of a sudden, how the f - - - can this be happening again to us again? It's just un-fricken-believable. It's surreal," MacGrath said.

The prospect of maybe — just maybe — a repeat of one of the greatest harness racing stories of the modern era has piqued attention in a time when the sport could really use another hero.

That Beach Glass is a son of Somebeachsomewhere — from the tiny last crop sired by the late superstar, no less — should be no surprise. That he's trained by MacGrath, driven by his



long-time friend Paul MacDonell and owned by a modified version of the same Schooner Stable from the Canadian Maritimes — all of whom campaigned Somebeachsomewhere — gives the Beach Glass story the same richness as that of his superstar

sire who is the subject of a book (Somebeachsomewhere: The Harness Racing Legend from a One-Horse Stable), documentary (Somebeachsomewhere: Horse of a Lifetime) and general hero worship.

MacGrath is the owner of several car and tire dealerships in the Maritimes, but has a lifetime of experience training a small

stable of horses. Fifteen years ago, he cobbled together five businesspeople from the Maritimes to buy a single Ontariosired horse. He picked out one yearling in October of that year on his first trip to Lexington, KY and was able to purchase that horse, bred by Stephanie Smith-Rothaug of West Jefferson, OH, at exactly his limit.

"I didn't have \$40,100. I had \$40,000. I said, 'If he goes for \$40,000, I own him," MacGrath once said.

On Oct. 4, 2006 at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale, the hammer fell on hip number 268 at exactly \$40,000.

Beach Glass is a homebred, which might make his rapid ascension more unlikely than that of his Hall of Fame papa, until you look at Beach Glass' bloodlines. Apart from his sire, who stood at Hanover Shoe Farms and has produced the winners of more than \$164 million from 10 crops, Beach Glass is out of the Bettors Delight mare Im With Her, a daughter of prolific mare Hattie. In 2016, MacGrath and Co. purchased Im With Her — originally named, appropriately-enough, Have Faith Hanover — from the Hanover Shoe Farms consignment at the Standardbred Horse Sales Company yearling auction in Hanover, PA for \$90,000.

"We bought her 100 per cent to breed to Beach and, obviously, we're partners with Hanover and we wanted to deal with them if we could. And I really wanted a Bettors Delight mare because they were showing up breeding to Beach," MacGrath said.

Im With Her was a handful as a 2-year-old — "She was nasty, really nasty, kicking, squealing and pouty," MacGrath said — but

still earned over \$50,000 as a rookie, including fifth-place finishes in both her elimination and final of the 2017 Breeders Crown for 2-year-old pacing fillies at Harrah's Hoosier Park.

In January of 2018, while MacGrath was prepping Im With Her in Florida for her 3-year-old season, cancer claimed Somebeachsomewhere at the untimely age of 13.

MacGrath had hoped for big things from Im With Her on the track during her sophomore year because most in Hattie's family have been unremarkable 2-year-olds that starred at 3. But when Somebeachsomewhere died and there was only a small batch of frozen semen left that could be legally used that year, he consulted Hanover's vice-president Dr. Bridgette Jablonsky about his best course of action — to continue racing Im With Her and breed her via embryo transfer with a surrogate mare or take her off the track to breed her.

"(Jablonsky) said to me, 'If I was your partner, I would be pushing to pull her from training and breed her herself. She's the one that's going to carry the good foal. She's the one that's going to get the job done here.' She said the only time we would use a donor or a surrogate mare is if we had to. She said, 'You don't have to. You didn't buy this mare to race, you bought her to breed, so I'd be breeding her.' So, that's what we did," MacGrath said.

Beach Glass is from a final crop of 28 Somebeachsomewhere foals, which is reminiscent of the story of Cam Fella, Somebeachsomewhere's equally-prolific maternal great-grand-sire. Cam Fella also battled cancer and from his final crop of just 19 foals came arguably his greatest offspring, daughter Eternal Camnation.

MacGrath said he only can dream Beach Glass will eventually pay similar tribute to his late sire, as unlikely as that might be now.

He's prepared to wait find out.

"He was a very late-developing colt and I just waited on him," MacGrath said, explaining why Beach Glass first showed up in September.

Beach Glass has had just one qualifier in Truro, NS on Sept. 12 and three overnight starts at Woodbine Mohawk Park through which he has remained undefeated. Despite having limited experience, MacGrath said Beach Glass acts like a 6-year-old that can be driven with two fingers.

"(Somebeachsomewhere) was the same way, just really, really smart horses," MacGrath said.

The Maritime connection is just as strong. Somebeachsomewhere also got his start in Truro to great acclaim from the locals, but MacGrath laughed when asked if he was superstitious and simply wanted Beach Glass to follow his sire's story to the letter.

"If it wasn't for COVID we'd be in Florida. Make no mistake about that," MacGrath said. "Qualifying him in Nova Scotia, that was 100 per cent a timing thing. I wanted to try for the Breeders Crown. I thought we had that kind of colt. If I had shipped him (to Ontario) and had to wait a week to qualify (it might have impacted his schedule). I thought I could qualify him in Truro – the qualifying time was 2:01. I had been in 2:01 five weeks before that... I thought if he wasn't ready to pace in :54 or :55 off of that, then he's not what I think he is anyway. So, I took him to Toronto. We shipped him up the day after we qualified him and I said to Paul, 'Let's throw him in next week. The horse has had it easy, I've been easy on him all summer, so throw him in for next week to race. We'll take him into Mohawk and go a mile in 2:08 and let him see the facility and race him.' That's what we did."

On Sept. 20, in his career pari-mutuel debut, Beach Glass won by six-and-a-half lengths in 1:54.1 at Woodbine Mohawk Park. On Sept. 28, he dropped his mark to 1:52.2 with a two-length score at the Campbellville, ON track before getting a week off prior to Thursday's start.

The goal now is the Breeders Crown at the Meadowlands and, perhaps, the Governor's Cup at the East Rutherford, NJ track after that. But MacGrath is more concerned about next year than this one.

"Obviously, I let the horse do the talking and they are ready when they are ready to be ready. I wouldn't be as keen to go

to the Breeders Crown if it wasn't for Paul (MacDonell)... not going *for* Paul, but knowing that Paul is not going to hurt this horse. He's got a lot of experience and I'm quite comfortable doing that. I would not do it with lots of drivers, but I'm good to go," MacGrath said.

"All we want to do is go down there and educate him a little. Put him up against the big boys and see how he handles them... and don't tear him all to hell. Paul will not do that."

MacGrath's fierce loyalty to MacDonell — their friendship and partnership goes back to a chance meeting at Greenwood Raceway in 1985 — is admirable. MacGrath takes umbrage with those that suggest Beach Glass is just the horse to give the 58-year-old Hall of Fame driver a career boost.

"You wouldn't believe the people who have said something about it giving Paul's career a lift. I said, 'I don't know what you're talking about," MacGrath said. "He doesn't drive a bad race when he's on any power... What pisses the owners and trainers off is that he doesn't leave with the 75-1 shots. I wonder why?"


As for his fellow owners in the Schooner II Stable of Truro, NS, most involved in Somebeachsomewhere's ownership are on board again — minus Reg Petitpas and Pamela Dean and MacGrath's friend and business partner Garry Pye, who died in April at age 77.

Stu Rath and Jamie Bagnell are back and Pye's widow Mary-Louise has replaced her late husband in the group.

"She said, 'I want to be in, Garry loved it. I'm in," MacGrath said. "I was very happy."

MacGrath said he couldn't have better partners.

As for Beach Glass, some observers have said he reminds them of Somebeachsomewhere in stature.

"What I would say is that he's a bit taller than Beach," MacGrath said. "I'd say that he's not quite the specimen as far as his hind end, shoulders and stuff, but it's a little deceiving because he's quite a bit taller and, you know, the higher up you go, the more lanky that you look. One thing is for sure, Beach wore 57-inch hopples and this colt's got a 61-and-a-half, so that's real.

"Their demeanor is a lot the same. (Beach Glass is) very intelligent and he loves people. He loves attention. He loves walking. He loves the grass. We go in and spoil him, of course, every night and did all winter before he started racing like this and he just waits for us and he's talking as soon as we come in the door.

"He loves to have his picture taken. He's a gentleman. He's a little bit difficult in the winner's circle, like Beach was."

MacGrath is the last person to get ahead of himself. For now, Beach Glass is just "a decent colt, so far, and maybe more," but he likes the positive feedback he's getting from other horsepeople.

"The same horsemen that very quickly saw Beach for who he was... they are seeing this guy. Who knows how this ends, but

they see that he's a little bit special," said MacGrath who has the colt at Classy Lane Stables in Ontario. "Ben Wallace said to me the other day, 'When are you going home?' and I said, 'Well, it'll depend on him. If he stays the way that he is right now, I'm here until the Governor's Cup.' He said, 'Oh, you're here awhile.'

"He's a very nice horse and it's all about now how deep he is and how healthy he can stay. I think he's got the talent. I think he's got as much talent as any of the 2-year-olds. He's not as seasoned as some of them, but that might be a good thing right now.

"I just hope it's going to be a good story, like Beach."


Don't most of us?

Can excitement be injected into the sport?

Using a track as a testing lab for change like Major League Baseball has with the Atlantic League could be worth exploring

In the last 50 years, the length of a Major League Baseball game has increased from two and a half hours to three hours and 11 minutes. In 1980, about 12 per cent of trips to the plate ended in a strikeout; in 2021 it's about double. Incredibly, the time between batted balls has reached four full minutes.

"What comes out of our research is that fans want more baseball in the baseball game," says Morgan Sword, the league's executive vice president of baseball operations.

"To me, the root cause is the rules," says Sword, "the dimensions of the playing field, the equipment, the essence of the game."

Changing the rules of a game is a minefield; perhaps even more so in a sport with so many purists like baseball has. But MLB Commissioner Rob Manfred has not shied away from it, believing the game has been hacked through great coaching and smart analytics and it needs to be addressed. Some of what's been tried or proposed to reverse engineer the hack is frankly quite radical. This includes making the bags bigger (to encourage steals), moving the pitching rubber back one full foot, using "Trackman" to call balls and strikes, and allowing a player to steal first base.

Because most of us would consider such changes heresy, the MLB didn't implement this in Yankee Stadium or Fenway. They needed an incubator; a Menlo Park or Bell Labs, and they found it in the Atlantic League. The players and team owners were brought on board, a deal was signed and away they went. Thus far the experiments show some promise.

Over in our sport, harness racing has also been hacked. It's a speed game with fancy bikes and good drivers in horizontal contortions making the front end unassailable (especially on half-mile tracks), and 1990's movement during a race unrealistic. This has resulted in plenty of grumbling from fans, while bettors are chased to the exits with short-priced favorite win percentages reaching the troposphere.

To combat this, people like John Campbell have worked on uniform rules, and just this spring the Meadowlands created a committee designed to explore how to make the races more competitive. Both initiatives showed promise; however, is it biting off more than can be chewed? Experimenting at the highest handle harness track in the world with stakes purses is probably not optimal. And John Campbell is a magician in a race bike, but herding cats in a multitude of racing jurisdictions is like steering Life Sign to Jupiter.


I wonder if there's not a simpler solution. Why can't harness racing copy Major League Baseball and find a place to try new ideas?

Take for example Georgian Downs near Barrie, ON, whose claim to fame coincidentally was "Xtreme Racing Day" held several years in a row in the early 2010's. It, like many slots tracks, has lower handles, but it does attract good horses, trainers and drivers. It's a professionally run five-eighths mile racetrack.

Can ideas to hopefully improve the game be experimented with at such a place? With Ontario Racing under a tight knit government structure and power sharing system, it does not seem overly naïve to think this possible.

Changing the sport of harness racing is difficult. It's spread out, and there are many fiefdoms to get on-side, but if we shrink it to one track in one jurisdiction, as MLB has done, it doesn't seem quite as daunting. No-holes racing, double-tiered handicaps, old bikes, paying the leader at the half-mile pole a part of the purse? All radical ideas. But if a traditional game as American as apple pie can experiment with something as pure as the 60 feet six inches to home plate, what's our excuse?

Rockin Nola records fourth Indiana Super Final victory

It's on to the Breeders Crown for the 5-yearold pacing mare.

A dozen new Indiana Sires Stakes (ISS) champions were crowned Friday evening (Oct. 15) at Harrah's Hoosier Park. **Rockin Nola** once again added her name to the list of final winners in the state by virtue of a 1:48.4 triumph. The victory not only secured the pacing mare's fourth Super Final score, but it also earned her a return trip to the Breeders Crown for the partnership of J P Racing LLC and Suttons Bay Racing.

"Having a horse of that caliber and that consistency over the years is amazing. It's a tribute to Joe and Joey and LeWayne (Miller) when she was 2," said Mike Johnson, who, with trainer Joe Putnam, comprise J P Racing. "We've always taken care of her. We didn't over-race her. That's why I think she's good now. She's really good right now."

Just how good is Rockin Nola? Racing is predicated on the progression of a horse. Trainers hope to turn babies with potential into young racehorses. Then the goal becomes developing a good 3-year-old. Next is the transitional 4-year-old campaign followed by open class racing should your pupil continue to move forward. Consider that at each stage, Rockin Nola has earned a Super Final victory. There are several Indiana-sired trotters and pacers that have collected multiple finals wins during their careers, but the only other horse to record wins at 2, 3, 4 and 5 in ISS finals competition was the great pacing mare Go On BB.

Friday night, Rockin Nola collected her 30th career trip to the winner's circle, reaching the wire nearly two lengths in front as the favorite in the \$70,000 event. Only **Little Rocket Man's** 1:48.3 victory in the final for older stallion and gelding pacers was faster. Bred by Mahlon Lambright, the 5-year-old Rockin Image—Gottogetoutmore mare has pieced together an impressive racing resume. Making her 63rd start, the pacer has hit the board 50 times. The win added another \$35,000 to her bankroll, which now sits at \$727,007. Rockin Nola was a \$15,000 purchase at the Hoosier Classic sale.

"What we do for a living with the horses, this is what everybody dreams of, having a champion horse. ABC Mercedes, when he came along, he was a phenomenal trotter and had an incredible career," said Putnam. "You're kind of looking for the next one, and here comes Rockin Nola. It is just another blessing to have her in our barn."

With her success, Rockin Nola is drawing comparisons to a former Putnam trainee, millionaire trotter ABC Mercedes, as well as another seven-figure earner, Bridge To Jessie's. Over the course of his career, ABC Mercedes won Indiana Sires Stakes finals at ages 2, 3, 5 and 6. Friday evening, Bridge To Jessie's raced second in the \$50,000 final for stallion and gelding trotters while in search of his fifth title.

"Keeping her at that level for that long, Bridge To Jesse's comes to mind. He's been a great horse for a long time. ABC Mercedes for Joe was a great horse for a long time. Nola, hopefully we can keep her going like that," said Johnson. "She enjoys racing and she's very fit. I think she's got a lot left in the tank, hopefully."

The mare has a lot left in the tank due to her careful management. This summer's slate is a prime example. Putnam was strategic in setting up the calendar for his star, pointing toward Friday night and the Breeders Crown that lies ahead. To do that, he gave her a month-long rest from mid-July to mid-August in order to help her stay sharp when it mattered most.

"She's been great all year, but we gave her a month off in the heat of the summer. As the year has worn on, she's gotten, in our opinion, better and better. The speeds are fast now, but the most incredible thing about her, in my mind for this year, all nine of her wins have been sub 1:50. Even as a horseman that has done this for a few days, it's just amazing," the conditioner offered.

Since returning to action Aug. 21, Rockin Nola has proven tough to beat. With regular driver Joey Putnam in the bike, the 5-year-old established a new Hoosier Park track record in her



Rockin Nola (Joey Putnam) recorded her fourth Indiana Sires Stakes Super Final victory when she won the \$70,000 final for pacing mares on Friday at Harrah's Hoosier Park in 1:48.4. first start back, pacing in 1:48.4. She relinquished the record a week later, finishing a quarter length behind Mystical Carrie in 1:48.3. Including the Super Final tally, Rockin Nola has won four of her last six attempts, including three in a row. Heading into the Breeders Crown she is in fine form. Last season, the mare made her Crown debut as Hoosier Park hosted the fall championships. She finished sixth.

"She had a few minor foot issues going into the Breeders Crown last year. All in all, we still thought she showed a good effort. We felt like if it works out again and she's racing great, we'll give her another opportunity," Putnam said. "She's arguably had a better 5-year-old year than a 4-year-old year, so here we are, going to New Jersey."

This week the connections will focus on the Crown while also turning their attention to yearling shopping at the Hoosier Classic sale after purchasing babies in Lexington. The journey with Rockin Nola is not complete, but that doesn't stop Johnson from trying to find the next great horse. He appreciates the fact they don't come around that often.

"It's still fun looking for the next Nola. That's the game, right? You try and find something that will even make the sires stakes. Just making the sires stakes is a big deal," he explained. "To win the sires stakes final four years in a row, you don't even think of that when you're picking one out; it's almost impossible. We're just very grateful to have her. It's been quite a ride."

Freshman and sophomore Super Finals

Harrah's Hoosier Park press release by Emily Ratcliff:

Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino played host to Hoosier Champions Night Friday (Oct. 15) and the 15-race program provided a fitting conclusion to the 2021 ISS season. The summer-long ISS culminated with the crowning of 12 new champions with purses offered exceeding \$2.4 million. Light showers and coolers temperatures marked the evening but did not slow the tempo as the evening was highlighted by exciting racing action and a track record performance.

Two-Year-Old Filly Pace

After scoring in the opener in the older trot with **Whata Swan**, Trace Tetrick continued his hot start, teaming up with trainer Brian Brown and **Trick Of The Light** in the first \$270,000 Super Final of the evening for 2-year-old filly pacers. Trick Of The Light settled in third in the early stages of the race before she made a backstretch brush to the front. Once getting to the front, Trick Of The Light wouldn't relinquish the lead from that point forward, holding off a host of challengers in the stretch to score the victory in 1:51:1. Ms Quick Sand and Brandon Bates got up for second at a price of 77-1, with Always Gonna B You and John De Long rounding out the trifecta.

"She has been racing pretty well heading into tonight, we though she had a pretty good shot," Brown said in the winner's circle. "She was really good early in the season, we went in :51 in her second start and that may have taken a bit out of her, but she's a nice strong filly and she dug in and fought hard tonight."

With the victory, Trick Of The Light finished her freshman campaign with three victories in nine starts and \$227,250 in seasonal earnings for owners Country Club Acres, Joe Sbrocoo and Kirk Nichols. Bred by Adam Eicher, the daughter of Odds On Equuleus out of the Dragon Again mare, Gordjus established a new lifetime mark with the 1:51:1 score.

Three-Year-Old Filly Trot

The \$250,000 Indiana Sire Stakes Super Final for 3-year-old filly trotters would serve as race five on the 15-race card, with favoritism falling to eventual race winner, **Shirley Goodness**. Driver Peter Wrenn put Shirley Goodness into play early in the mile, quickly landing in the second spot behind LeWayne Miller and Country Girl Charm. Country Girl Charm led the field through hot early fractions. As second choice Swift Swanda launched her bid on the final turn, Shirley Goodness waited for room up the inside before exploding home with a powerful :27:2 final fraction to score in 1:53:3. Doug Rideout trainees Queen Of All and Four Under Par rounded out the top three with John De Long and Yannick Gingras in the bike respectively.

"We were really excited about racing this filly tonight," trainer

Melanie Wrenn said. "We added Lasix a few starts back and that really seemed to turn her around a bit and she's been sharp heading into the Super Final."

Owners Bill Beechy, Bradley Maxwell and Kenneth Frieder now face the decision of potentially entering the daughter of Swan For All into the Breeders Crown eliminations on Oct. 23. With tonight's score, Shirley Goodness has won five of 11 on the season, and catapulted her career earnings to \$364,445.

Two-Year-Old Filly Trot

Sire Swan For All scored his third Indiana Sire Stakes final victory with **M-M's Dream** in the \$270,000 2-year-old filly trot Super Final. Regular pilot Sam Widger had his work cut out for him as he navigated traffic trouble throughout the entire mile. Widger waited until the far turn to put M-M's dream into play, slipping into what would appear to be the perfect second over position behind the cover of Jusmakinyalook and Jordan Ross. Into the stretch, Jusmakinyalook and Ross made a costly break in front of Widger and M-M's dream, causing Widger to take evasive action in the lane. Even with the slight detour, M-M's Dream powered home with a :27 final quarter to chase down race favorite Fleurie and Peter Wrenn to score the victory in a lifetime best 1:55. Fleurie held on for second with Simply Right and Hall of Famer Tim Tetrick finished third.

"She was a bit hot tonight, hotter than I like her to be," Widger said after the race. "I really just wanted to get her flat through



the first turn and let her settle into the race, from there even with the breaker in front of her in the stretch, she still had a target to shoot at and she's a fighter. She loves her job."

It was the fourth straight victory on the season for the Henry Graber Jr. trainee, and sixth in eight seasonal starts for the freshman filly. Owned by the Eleven Star Stables, Frank Baldachino and the Hillside Stables, the \$18,500 Hoosier Classic purchase was bred by Mervin J Miller and has now banked \$268,462 for her connections.

Two-Year-Old Trotting Colts

Dover In Motion provided a fitting conclusion to his freshman stakes season with a dominant, track record setting 1:53.2 score in the \$250,000 Indiana Sires Stakes Super Final for 2-year-old trotting colts and geldings. With Ricky Macomber Jr. in the bike, Dover In Motion made his move to the lead just before the three-quarters and never looked back. The 1:53.2 time established a new track record at Harrah's Hoosier Park for 2-year-old trotting geldings, a mark that was previously held by former Indiana Sires Stakes champion TJ's Top Pick. Ponda Adventure and Trace Tetrick were second best while Swan Captain and John DeLong finished third. With the win, Dover In Motion is Harrah's Hoosier Park's newest track record holder and remains undefeated in Indiana Sires Stakes action this season.

"There can be a lot of pressure with a colt like him," trainer Jamie Macomber said in the winner's circle. "But he makes it easy. He's just good at everything he does and we are lucky to have him."

Owned by M&M Racing and Norbert Joseph Maza, the gelded son of Dover Dan—Keystone Sadie has now won eight of 9 lifetime starts. With the win, Dover In Motion now sports a lifetime bankroll of \$309,400. Dover In Motion was bred by Lyle Dean Slabach.

Three-Year-Old Filly Pace

All eyes were on the Panther Hanover filly **Hot Mess Express** as she looked to put the finishing touches on an undefeated Indiana Sire Stakes campaign in the 3-year-old filly pace division. John De Long was aboard the 1-9 Tony Alagna trainee as they floated out from the three hole, taking the first turn wide as the Tetrick Brothers threw down the gauntlet in the opening quarter. Tim Tetrick and Pure Cotton came out on top over Trace Tetrick and Skyway Brittney through the blistering 25:4 opening panel. Hot Mess Express cleared briefly to the lead up the backstretch but was quickly covered up by 2020 Indiana Sire Stakes Champion Somethingbeautiful and LeWayne Miller to the half in :54:1. De Long waited patiently before marching up the inside in the stretch, taking advantage of a :27:2 final guarter to score by a length and a half in 1:50:0. Kobe's Gigi closed from the clouds with Matt Krueger following a miscue behind the gate to get up for second, Somethingbeautiful held on for third.

"He's a been a very nice horse for us," trainer Melanie Wrenn said in the winner's circle. "I didn't expect him to be that dominant tonight, but he's been racing well and seems really good right now. He's got a few of the stakes left here at Hoosier Park and then he will be done for the year. It's been a great year for him."

With the win, the gelded son of Swan For All—Sunday Yankee recorded his seventh win from 14 starts this season. Owned in partnership by David McDuffee, and L&L Devisser LLC, Swingforthefences has now won 10 of 24 lifetime while bankrolling \$452,940 in purse earnings. Swingforthefences was bred by Concord Stud Farm LLC.

Two-Year-Old Pacing Colts

The biggest upset of the evening was found in the \$270,000 Indiana Sires Stakes Super Final for 2-year-old pacing colts and geldings when **Dalby Hanover** and Joey Putnam crossed the wire first at 58-1. After very hot first-half fractions, Dalby Hanover came storming home from off the pace to score in 1:50.2 over Thunder Country and John DeLong. The 1:50.2 clocking was a new lifetime best for the Britney Dillon trainee.

"I felt good coming around the last turn," Putnam said in the winner's circle. "With a really hot tempo up front, I loved the set-up of the race.

"When I asked him turning for home, I knew he had plenty of pace. I kept asking him and he kept pacing all the way to the wire. He's a really nice colt."

The gelded son of Rockin Image—Don't Deny Me recorded his third win from nine seasonal starts. Owned by Charles Stein and bred by Hanover Shoe Farms, Dalby Hanover has now earned \$200,962 in lifetime purse earnings.

Three-Year-Old Pacing Colts


The final \$270,000 Indiana Sires Stakes Super Final of the evening was the 3-year-old colt and gelding pacers and it was **Roll Em** and Tim Tetrick who took home top honors. Staging a big rally late in the lane - a :26.2 closing quarter to be exact, Roll Em tracked down the pace-setting Virgo and Trace Tetrick to get the win by nearly two lengths.

"I didn't know a whole lot about the horse coming into tonight," Tetrick said in the winner's circle. "They told me he was a little bit lazy and wasn't super quick but would just keep coming and that's what he did tonight.

"I was hoping for a little more action up front. It worked out for us though because once he got straightened out he just kept coming."

Trained by Ron Burke, Roll Em recorded his seventh win of the season from 18 trips behind the gate. The gelded son of Time To Roll—Feetonthedashboad is owned by Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi, Frank Baldachino and Beasty LLC. Roll Em was bred by David and Karen Arrenholz.

The owner from Ontario has already purchased 37 yearlings this fall and was the largest individual buyer of horses in Lexington.

"My goal is to have a lot of fun and visit as many winner's circles as I am able to, both next year and in the years to come," so saith the largest individual buyer of horses (32) and spender of dollars (more than \$2.3 million) at the recently-concluded Lexington Selected Yearling sale.

When asked if he is done for the year, Steve Heimbecker said that he is nowhere near done.

"There is still the upcoming London (Virtual) Yearling Sale and of course, Harrisburg. To this point, all of my buying has been focused on colts. In the upcoming sales I intend to buy some fillies and concentrate on Ontario breds. I live in Ontario and hope to be a factor in racing right here, both in the high quality overnight races, stakes races and in the Ontario Sires Stakes events."

Prior to the Fall of 2020, Heimbecker was relatively unknown outside of Ontario.

He started going to Greenwood Raceway with his father sometime in the 1980s.

He started betting on the horses. That led to greater interest and in the years 2004 and 2005 he invested in a few claimers.

However, he had more important interests. He was quite involved with his wife Joanna in raising a family composed of his son Calum, 16 and daughters Carys, 13 and Rori, 9.

For 20 years he was on the road to financial success, utilizing the combination of working long days and nights and some good fortune in the financial field.

"I felt it was time to have some real fun and enjoy the fruits of my toil and good fortune. Those who know me, know that I do not like to do things half assed. I'm usually all in, or not in. That is the way I've approached the horse business. I spent a good deal of money last year. I had some success on the racetrack, but not a whole lot of it. I'm an optimist by nature. So I look for better results next year and in the years to come."

(717) 637-8931 fax: (717) 637-6766 theblackbook.com You identified yourself as a major yearling buyer last year, but you have really amplified your status beginning especially with this year's sale in Ohio and then going on to the Lexington sale. What do you look for in your yearling purchases?

"Of course, pedigree comes first, then I go from there. I peruse the catalogs carefully. I also look for value. But at this point in time there was very little perceived value to be found — especially in the offerings at this year's Lexington Sale. Of course, when the results are known next year at this time, even some of the most costly yearlings will have turned out to be bargains. That's why we spend the big money.

"I watch the videos. I like a quick moving, athletic horse. Then I look at or have others whose opinions I respect look at the individuals. I wasn't able to secure my number one pick at the Lexington Sale. He was Hip No. 32, Cypress Hanover, the full brother to When Dovescry. He is an awesome colt. Nancy Takter bought him for \$475,000. I was the underbidder at \$450,000, the most I've bid on a yearling, but wasn't able to get him. I've spoken to Nancy and she still might be able to get me in for a piece of the action."

What pedigrees do you look for? Do you have any favorites?

"I guess I favor what most people do. That's why they cost so much," he said, laughing. "I love and especially want to see Somebeachsomewhere in the pedigrees of the pacing-bred yearlings. He is likely the greatest and most influential sire of this era. He was a great, great sire himself. His sons and daughters are carrying on the tradition. Captaintreacherous, Downbytheseaside and Huntsville already seem to be well established. I intend to partner with my friend Brad Grant on some Stay Hungry yearlings, perhaps some that he bought in

(717) 637-8931 fax: (717) 637-6766 theblackbook.com Lexington and some that he will undoubtedly buy in Harrisburg. Then there is Papi Rob Hanover whose first foals will be arriving next year. There are some who believe that Papi Rob Hanover was SBSW's most talented son.

"With trotters, I love Walner. So does everybody else and why not? He first crop has been downright amazing with both colts and fillies. There are some who believe that his daughter Venerable could be the 2021 Horse of the Year. There are lots of other choices. Of course Muscle Hill is still great. So are Chapter Seven and Bar Hopping. Old Cantab Hall is still churning them out."

Any other remarks on Lexington?

"Speaking in generalities, today's breeders are turning out a fantastic product. The horses looked great and I feel certain that a good many of them will perform well on the racetrack. I loved the atmosphere and the enthusiasm displayed by just about everybody I encountered there."

You bought a lot of yearlings. Who will train them?

"In the States, most of my horses will be trained by Julie Miller and Nancy Takter. Here in Canada, they will be mostly trained by Dave Menary, Gregg McNair, Aaron Byron and Amanda Fine.

"You may have noticed that three of the six that I will use are women. I believe strongly in girl power. That is not by accident.

"From my experience, women are especially adept with horses and communicate well with them. Some of that might relate to the fact that women outnumber me in my household," he said, laughing.

"I am especially impressed by Amanda Fine. Her work ethic is just amazing. She has done extremely well working with little pedigree and buying power. She now has some of both. I look for great things from her.

"We have, so far, purchased 37 yearlings, counting those bought in Ohio, the Winbak Ontario sale and Lexington.

"I also have a few overnight horses with Julie and Andy Miller's son, Tyler.

"I really want to support young people and be with people I like.

"I'm not sure of the exact number, but guessing I'd say I have close to 60 horses in training."



You mentioned your children. Please tell us about them.

"My son Calum is the oldest at 16. He is a much better than average soccer player. He will be going over to England next year to play competitively.

"Next is my daughter Carys. She is 13. She is also very much involved in sports with significant time spent with basketball.

"The youngest, my daughter Rori, is nine. She is the only horse lover among them. She takes a great interest in the horses already. I expect that this will grow as time goes on."

How do you see the harness business and what of its future?

"Unfortunately, we exist in a bubble — a very small bubble. We need to expand that bubble. We desperately need exposure. So many people, actually the vast majority of people, do not even know that we exist.

"The Standardbred industry here in Canada extends from coast to coast, yet few know we are here. There are so many nice people including some real characters in the game. Speaking for myself I'm here for the long haul. I want to be involved and I want to contribute.

Do you see yourself being involved in the breeding business?

"I wouldn't close the door on it. But right now I would say it's premature. I'll concentrate on racing. Most of all, I want to win races. The more the better. I'm guessing that we will develop some good fillies that will tempt me to send them to become broodmares. Of course, we all dream about developing that great stallion prospect that will go on to stand at a major breeding farm. If that would come to pass, I might be tempted to get into the breeding business. Who wouldn't?"

I'll close as I do most recent columns with COVID-19. How has it affected you?

"It hasn't been as bad for me as it has for others. It has been especially rough on the kids. To some degree it has prevented them from being what they are —kids.

"It has been challenging and restraining and has created difficult employment issues for both employers and employees. Being the optimist that I am, I know we will get through it hopefully sooner rather than later."

More on inbreeding, and another shoutout to Ake

My thanks to Dino Romano for his kind words and the interesting question he raised in a recent email.

Mr. Romano asks why there is such reluctance on the part of standardbred breeders to line breed, let alone inbreed. My take is that the popular breeding patterns of the present day don't lend themselves to close breeding, and there isn't a conscious decision on anyone's part to avoid breeding close.

At the moment, our breed is so diversified, pedigree-wise, that most of the mares being bred to the popular horses today have different pedigrees, at least in the first two generations, from the horses they're mated with.

As a market breeder, this kid has always done his matings with the primary concern of providing a yearling with the highest possible market value. Assuming that concept applies to most, if not all, breeders today, in a few years our breeds, both pacers and trotters, will have narrowed so that closer breeding in inevitable.

That will happen when a new sire like Walner and his sire, Chapter Seven, both have sons and daughters in the stud on the trotting side, and Captaintreacherous and his sire, Somebeachsomewhere, do the same for pacers. Right now, the majority of the leading sires are relatively young horses. Things will change when their sons and daughters have sons and daughters in the breeding ranks. When those days come, closer breeding will, to overwork the word, be inevitable.

Here, a personal digression. If one wants to produce a "super horse", the way to do it is by inbreeding. That means the sum of the two generations in which the same ancestor appears is six or less. In my head, I keep coming back to the immortal trotting filly, CR Kay Suzie, whose grandsire and granddam were full brother and sister. If you're game enough to shoot for the moon, that's the way to do it.

With the other major yearling sale still to come, plus soon after it'll be time to book your mares, there's something to be aware of with second crop sires.

Down through the years, there have been a number of instances where a new sire suddenly blossomed with his second crop of 2-year-olds. There is no logic for this, at least not that I can find, but it still is a fact.

By the same token, there have been more than a few horses who hit heights with their first crop that they never reached again.

Let me quickly say that I don't expect Walner to suddenly fade from view, and the same for Downbytheseaside. They are solid, and they'll keep siring good horses from their future crops.

But where this second crop success can apply is to a horse like Fear the Dragon. (Full disclosure: I am quite involved with Bruce Trogdon's breeding operation, and particularly-so with Fear the Dragon, whom Bruce owns.) Here, I'll put my money where my mouth is. Meaning, I'll breed our one pacing mare to Fear the Dragon in 2022.

Something else worth noting about yearling sales, if you understand that there's no correlation between a mare's racing performance and her ability to produce top horses. Here, I know I'm crying in the wilderness, because the yearling buyers in Lexington paid premium prices for yearlings out of fancy race mares, and it will be the same at Harrisburg.

This, again, and again, and again, and again, goes directly to the total disparity between every horse's phenotype, which is the visible horse, and the genotype, which is the horse's genetic makeup. No matter how many great miles a mare went winning so many stakes and so much money, it has nothing to do with her reproductive ability.

So, if racetrack performance is not to be considered when looking for future broodmares, the question is where does one look? The answer here is easy: the yearling sales. There are scads of well-bred fillies being offered both at Lexington and Harrisburg, if you just look for them. I'm not talking about the first session movie stars, who sell through the roof, to combine metaphors.

I'm talking about the fillies much later in the sale, the ones by the less popular sires. There were a goodly number of them here in Lexington, and there are quite a few more at Harrisburg. The question then arises about whether to train them.

I say no. If they've got a strong pedigree, that will carry their first foals through the sales ring at good prices, and then they'll establish themselves once their first two foals get to the races.

And from a practical, breeder's standpoint, most 2-year-old fillies are mature enough to breed. That means, of course, avoiding small, immature individuals when you're doing your buying, but that's just good horsemanship. Unless that small, immature filly has a mouthwatering pedigree, and then she's worth waiting for her 3-year-old year.

Finally, Futurity Day at the Red Mile last week was a showcase for Andy McCarthy, who seemed to have made a down payment on the winner's circle, but also for Ake Svanstedt.

Svanstedt is in a class all by himself. There is no one else who can both drive and train at the highest possible level. He won two races last Sunday, with perfect drives both times. But beyond that, he is the smartest operator out there, which he proved once again by starting five horses in the Kentucky Futurity.

They finished third, fourth, and fifth, and with a total purse of \$561,000, they each earned substantial pay checks. Ake plays the game better than anyone else I know, and he is well overdue to be elected to the Hall of Fame.

As for Ake's wife, Sarah, if she offered to sell me a bridge, I'd ask how much was the down payment?





James MacDonald wins three Ontario Super Finals

Canada's leading driver James MacDonald won three Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Super Finals on Saturday (Oct. 16) at Woodbine Mohawk Park, taking down three of the four \$225,000 finals for 2-year-olds. MacDonald, the Lampman Cup winner as the leading driver in the OSS program in 2021, won the first two divisions with 2-year-old pacing filly **Prohibition Legal** and 2-year-old trotting filly **Adare Castle** and a later division with 2-year-old trotting colt **Twin B Archie**.

The card, which had \$1.8 million in OSS purses, also featured an upset win by Woodbine Mohawk Park announcer Ken Middleton, Jr.'s trainee **Bob Loblaw** in the 2-year-old colt pace and a triumph in the sophomore pacing colt division by Pepsi North America Cup champion **Desperate Man**.

Two-Year-Old Filly Pace — Prohibition Legal

In the first Super Final of the night, overwhelming 1-5 favorite **Prohibition Legal** remained undefeated in all six OSS starts in 2021, capping the year with a 1:52.1 victory in the \$225,000 event for 2-year-old pacing fillies that was one-and-a-quarter lengths ahead of stablemate Silver Label (7-2) and driver Sylvain Filion. Balance was third. The splits were: :27.1,:56.2 and 1:25.1. (**replay here**)

MacDonald drove Prohibition Legal to victory. The homebred daughter of Big Jim—Catch A Wish is owned by Millar Farms of Stouffville, ON and trained by Nick Gallucci who also grabbed show money with another homebred, Silver Label (Bettors Delight—Hidden Gem). The 1-2 finish pushed Gallucci over \$1 million in lifetime OSS trainer earnings.

Prohibition Legal improves to 8-1-0 in 9 career starts and her bankroll now sits at \$564,204.

Silver Label is now 6-2-0 in 8 starts and has earnings of \$341,726.

Two-Year-Old Filly Trot — Adare Castle

Adare Castle (2-5) blew past leader Mischevious Rose in midstretch to win the rookie trotting filly Super Final by six lengths in 1:56.3. Needa Little Magic was third. The splits were: :27.4, :57 and 1:27.1. (replay here)

The victory gave MacDonald back-to-back Super Final victories


to start the night and improved Adare Castle's record to 7-2-0 in 9 career starts and her earnings to \$486,037 for owner/trainer Mark Etsell and his partners Robert Newton, Graham Hopkins and Peter Porter.

Adare Castle, a daughter of Muscle Mass out of Pacific Edge, was bred by Eddie Lohmeyer of New Jersey and sold to Etsell for \$10,000 at the 2020 Standardbred Horse Sales Company yearling auction in Timonium, MD.

Three-Year-Old Filly Pace — Scarlett Hanover

Jugette winner **Scarlett Hanover** (Yannick Gingras) repeated as Super Final champion when she vaulted off cover in mid-stretch and pulled away to a 1:50.4 career best victory that was five lengths better than Bet On Becky. Voelz Delight was third. The splits were: :27.1, :55.3 and 1:23.2. (**replay here**)

Three-Year-Old Colt Trot — Fashion Frenzie

Even-money favorite **Fashion Frenzie**, bred by John Petrik of Moorefield, ON, won a three-horse battle in the lane to win the sophomore trotting colt Super Final in 1:53.4 and repeat as Super Final champ. Logan Park was two lengths back in second. Lexus Kody was third. The splits were: :26.4, :55.2 and 1:24.4. (replay here)

Louis-Philippe Roy drove the son of Archangel—Striking Fashion to victory for trainer Richard Moreau and owners Ecurie Francis Richard Inc, Mario Bourgea, Pierre Guillemette and Sylvain Richard.

The victory improved Fashion Frenzie's 2021 record to 6-3-0 in 12 starts and his career record to 11-3-0 in 19 outings. Fashion Frenzie has earned \$524,910 this year and \$729,685 lifetime.

Two-Year-Old Colt Pace — Bob Loblaw

Bob Loblaw came from another planet to score a 37-1 upset in the final strides of the rookie pacing colt Super Final. Sitting seventh at the top of the stretch, **Bob Loblaw** rocketed home in :27.2 to win by a neck in 1:53.

The homebred son of Sunshine Beach out of Lady Marina trained, owned and bred by Woodbine Mohawk Park announcer Ken Middleton, Jr. for his partners David Walls, James Grant and the Starting Centre Stables, was driven to victory by Sylvain Filion. Magical Arthur was second. Stonebridge Helios was a half-length behind the winner in

The win was the third of the year for Bob Loblaw — whom Middleton bred with the late Hall of Famer Bill Galvin — in 12 starts and improved his bankroll to \$233,657.

Two-Year-Old Colt Trot — Twin B Archie

MacDonald's third and final Super Final victory of the night came driving 7-2 shot **Twin B Archie** to a two-and-a-half-length upset of 1-5 favorite of Duly Resolved in 1:55.3. Kipper Whipr Snipr was third. The splits were: :28.4, :57.4 and 1:26.3. (**replay here**)

The victory improved Twin B Archie's record to 4-3-1 in 10 starts and upped his earnings to \$285,016 for trainer and part-owner Scott McEneny, who shares the son of Archangel—Affair Hall with Domenic Chiaravalle, Floyd Marshall and Martwest Racing Stable.

Twin B Archie was bred by Twinbrook Limited of Embro, ON and sold for \$52,000 at the 2020 Standardbred Horse Sales Company's yearling sale at Timonium, MD.

Three-Year-Old Colt Pace — Desperate Man

Pepsi North America Cup winner **Desperate** Man (9-5) bested a six-horse Super Final field of sophomore pacing colts, winning by one-and-a-quarter lengths over 4-5 favorite Bulldog Hanover in 1:49.3. Early leader Powertrain finished three-and-a-quarter lengths back in third. The splits were: :27.4, :55 and 1:22.1. (replay here)

The win improved the son of Shadow Play—Dreamlands Latte to 3-2-2 in 12 starts this year and upped his bankroll to \$767,594 this year and to the cusp of \$1 million lifetime (\$986,266, to be exact) for Kathy and John Cecchin and Nikki and Paul Davies, all of Arthur, ON.

Bred by Winbak Farms, Desperate Man was a \$20,000 purchase from the 2019 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale.

Three-Year-Old Filly Trot — Up And Ready

In the final Super Final of the night, **Up And Ready** (Doug McNair) pulled the pocket in mid-stretch and blew past 6-5 favorite HP Mama B to score a 1:55.1 victory in the division for sophomore trotting fillies. Hawaii (Scott Zeron) finished five-and-a-half lengths back in second. You Will Be Queen was third.

Up And Ready is trained by John Bax for Al Libfeld, Marvin and Lynn Katz and Sam Goldband. Bred by Diane Ingham and the late Harry Rutherford, Up And Ready, a daughter of Kadabra out of Glide By, was a \$300,000 purchase at the 2019 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale.

Harvesting handicappers

I tugged the ticket from the Turnpike toll machine and watched the mechanical arm rise. My passenger said, "Trey, you might be missing the mark with your schemes to harvest new owners. The future of your sport depends on gamblers. Without a steady stream of gambling money, the fate of racing will be an expensive hobby."

I nodded. "An astute observation. There will always be horses to race and owners to want to compete against each other. The weird thing is, while I have had people ask me about owning young horses, in twenty years, I never had a single person ask me to teach them how to read a program or handicap a race."

"Never?"

"Never," I replied.

"Perhaps your gambling reputation preceded you."

"True again, asking me for handicapping advice would be like going to a swami for stock market advice."

"Suppose a novice DID ask you for suggestions on wagering harness races? What would you say?"

"Well, first I would tell them, they could not make a dime wagering on trotters and pacers. I would forbid them from entering the world of handicapping harness races."

"Plausible deniability?" he asked.

"Yes, and reverse psychology. You see, for some of us, telling us we cannot do something is waving a red cape to a bull. Suggesting to me that I cannot do something will ensure a "hold my beer" reaction. I will try enthusiastically and repeatedly to prove you wrong."

"Suppose the novice persists and they still want to learn how to gamble on horse races. What do you tell them?"

"I'd tell them to do it privately. A cool aspect of living in 2021 is that you can learn anything without looking or sounding like a fool in public. With a laptop or cell phone, you could build a ukulele and then learn how to play it on your living room couch.

We can all learn stuff without heckling from a live audience. If you google – how to gamble on harness racing or how to read a harness racing program, multiple pages and videos will pop onto your screen."

He added, "Plus, potential gamblers can place bets using their keyboard."

"Exactly. Privacy is an important concept. Present company excepted, appearing stupid or asking for guidance in public annoys people."

"Any other words of wisdom?"

"Yes, a few ideas could be classified as compartmentalization. I would tell a novice to choose a single racetrack during the early days of picking equine trotters and pacers, perhaps choose a track like Northville Downs in Michigan. Get familiar with the horses and comfortable with the process for a few weeks."

"Reasonable."

"Then I'd suggest they begin with basic win, place, or show wagers. They should probably bet show wagers, as not to become discouraged or destitute. And AFTER each race, the newbie should block out a few minutes to look back at the program and see what they might have missed before the race."

He shuddered, "This is the most sense you have displayed since, well. ever."

"I know, I'm on a roll. The neophyte should wager small amounts, no sense being in a hurry to go broke. Plus, I believe in setting goals. I usually set the bar low so I can sort of step over it. For example, a novice gambler to horse racing could deposit fifty dollars in their wagering account on Monday and attempt to make it last until Friday. Wagering two-dollar show tickets would make this doable. The onsite gambling sites keep a running total of deposits and wagers, so all the math and record-keeping is taken care of for a player."

He chimed in, "I see. So if the new player follows your advice and has twenty dollars remaining on Friday, this will be classified as a success instead of what it is, a thirty-dollar loss."

I nodded. "Welcome to my world of wagering."

"Trey, this is excellent. One might call your suggested method, modest, concrete, measurable, building blocks under the cloak of anonymity."

With an eye-roll, I said, "Or, if you are not a pretentious walking dictionary, one could say it would help ease newbies into betting on horses."





Test Of Faith wins \$100,000 Courageous Lady at MGM Northfield Park

Test Of Faith strengthened her case for divisional Dan Patch honors by continuing her streak of Grand Circuit victories in Saturday's (Oct. 16) \$100,000 Courageous Lady for 3-year old filly pacers at MGM Northfield Park.

Driven by Hall of Famer David Miller, Test Of Faith sat the pocket through fractions of :26.3, :55 and 1:22.2 before tipping in the final quarter and winning by 2-¾ lengths in 1:50.2. The clocking ties the track record for sophomore filly pacers.

Oakwoodanabella IR (Ronnie Wrenn Jr.) carved the expeditious fractions and finished second, Think Of Galaxies (Matt Kakaley) followed the top-two the entire mile and finished third.

Brett Pelling conditions Test Of Faith for owners Melvin Segal, Kentuckiana Racing Stable and Eddie Gran.

Completing the field were Smothastenesewisky, Continualou and Summer Touch. State Of Mind was scratched sick.

Test Of Faith (Art Major – Cannae Cammie) now has 20 wins in 23 lifetime starts. Saturday's victory increased her career bankroll to \$1,205,239. She was heavily favored and returned \$2.20 to win.

The races leading up to the Grand Circuit feature consisted of eight \$60,000 Buckeye Stallion Series Finals.

Miss Cowboy Star (Long Tom—Emerald Myway) was able to wear down Purple Aura (Aaron Merriman) through the stretch to capture the Buckeye Stallion Series Championship for freshman filly trotters in 1:57.3. Purple Aura was stretched out by Miss Cowboy Star (Kurt Sugg) at the opening quarter of :28.3. Merriman was able to get a 29.4 breather through the second panel and tried to create some separation past three-quarters in 1:27.1. Purple Aura got leg-weary through the stretch, and Miss Cowboy Star came up the passing lane to by a head over a hard-charging Toes In The Water (Ryan Stahl). Miss Cowboy Star is owned by Rebecca Sugg, Steven Maas, and John Duke Sugg and the victory gave her career win eight in 12 starts this season.

After a slow start to her career, **Bittrsweetsymphony** (Well Said—Just Too Spoiled) put together a string of twelve straight wins heading into Saturday night's Buckeye Stallion Series Championship Final for 2-year-old filly pacers. Bittrsweetsymphony (Tyler Smith) sat just off the pace with She Means Business (Chris Lems) setting the pace early, through a quick first quarter of :27.2. Bittrsweetsymphony made her aggressive first-over move just past the half of :56.3. Heading up the backstretch, she cleared She Means Business and drew off in the stretch to win by 6-1/4 lengths in 1:53.2 over Love Me Hill (Ronnie Wrenn Jr.) and She Means Business, who held on for third. With the victory, she pushed her career earnings to over \$105,000. Bittrsweetsymphony is owned by CNC Stables LLC and David J. Miller.

All Gas No Brakes (Uncle Peter—Norse Comer) took no prisoners once clearing the lead and won the Buckeye Stallion Series Championship for 2-year-old colt & gelding trotters by 4-1/4 lengths in a new lifetime best 1:57.2. All Gas No Breaks (Trevor Smith) got away fourth and stayed out of trouble, with Stay Tuned (JD Wengerd) making a breakthrough the first turn. A Handsome Face (David Miller) secured the lead from Rose Run Xalted (Don Irvine Jr.) through the first quarter of :28.1. Smith began to make his first-over move at the half of :58 and cleared the lead past three-quarters in 1:27.1. All Gas No Brakes kicked clear through the stretch to win, increasing his bankroll to over \$70,000 in career earnings for Black Magic Racing LLC and trainer Todd Luther.

The 2-year-old colt and gelding pace had fireworks early as there were three different lead changes through the first 5/8ths of a mile. Dirge (Ronnie Wrenn Jr.) was able to make the lead just past the opening quarter of 27.4, but had to deal with immediate pressure from **Western Ready** (Western Vintage—My My Marie) at the half of :56. Once Western Ready (Aaron Merriman) made the lead he never looked back winning easily by 6-3/4 lengths in 1:52.1. With the victory, he pushes his career earnings to just over \$100,000 for owner Brendan Toops.

Fiesty Pistol (Triumphant Caviar—Franniegetyourgun) took advantage of a miscue by heavy-favorite Cash N Chips (Hunter Myers) to win the Buckeye Stallion Series Championship for 3-year-old filly trotters. Merriman guided Fiesty Pistol through fractions of :28.3, :58.2 and 1:27.3 in route to a one length victory in 1:57. Fiesty Pistol has amassed just over \$100,000 in career earnings for co-owners Christopher Beaver, David Meola, Donnald Robinson, and RBH Ventures Inc.

Disaronno Hill (Brett Miller) took the lead at the five-eighths pole and cruised to a 2-3/4 length victory in the Buckeye Stallion Series Championship for 3-year-old filly pacers in 1:53.3. Reachthruthesky As (Merriman) set the early pace, making it to the quarter in :27.2 and to the half in :56.1 before dealing with pressure from the eventual winner. Disaronno Hill is owned by the partnership of Carl Howard, Kiara and Tre Morgan, and trainer Virgil Morgan Jr. She now has 10 wins in 30 starts with over \$120,000 in career earnings.

Aggressively driven from post four, **Castyourcrown** (Matt Kakaley) made every pole a winning one in route to a victory

in the Buckeye Stallion Series Championship for 3-year-old colt and gelding trotters. Castyourcrown led through fractions of :28.3, :58.3, and 1:27.2 in route to a 2-1/4 length victory over Blank Space As (Trevor Smith) and Very Smart (Ryan Sthal). Castyourcrown is owned by Blake Daniels and is just shy of \$70,000 in career earnings.

Walkinafter Midnite scored from the rail to capture the sophomore colt pacing division in 1:54.1. Driver Trevor Smith sat the pocket and scored by way of the passing lane for trainer Jeff Smith and owner Bet The House LLC. The victory increases the pacers earnings to \$96,973. Sir Charles Of Sky (Chris Page) cut the mile and finished second. King's Cruiser (Tyler Smith) finished third.

George Napolitano, Jr. surpasses \$100 million

Since George Napolitano Jr. has established himself as a legend at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono with a mammoth amount of driving and training titles, it seems appropriate that a horse named Imarocnrollegend N would be the one who in winning made "George Nap" only the 26th driver to go over the \$100 million plateau in career earnings.

Napolitano characteristically hustled the imported Rock N Roll Hanover gelding to the lead, then let Keystone Phoenix take command with an early brush. Imarocnrollegend N moved from the pocket to challenge the pacesetter in the stretch and worked his way by the leader by 1½ lengths in 1:51.3 for trainer Lorenzo DeSimone, also co-owner with Jerry Zollo. Napolitano, the winningest driver at Pocono this year for the tenth straight season, achieved the earnings milestone in his 11,052nd lifetime triumph (he ranks 12th all-time in North American successes), and he would wind up with three victories on the day, one behind Jim Pantaleano.

There are only six cards remaining in the 2021 Pocono campaign; the next one is on Monday afternoon (Oct. 18), when the feature will be a \$17,500 pace for mares bringing together a well-balanced field of six. Program pages for the 12:30 card are available at https://www.phha.org/downsmsppps.html.

Gregg McNair earns fifth Johnston Cup title

Prior to having four horses in Saturday's \$1.8 million Super Final night at Woodbine Mohawk Park, trainer Gregg McNair had already capped off his fifth Johnston Cup-winning season as the Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) program's leading trainer.

"I used to follow it quite a few years ago, and geez it was a hard thing to win," said McNair, who won his first three titles from 2012 to 2014 and his fourth in 2019. "It's quite a thing to say that you've won it a few times. We're sure happy about that."

With four more opportunities to pad his lead, McNair currently

has 209 points earned through 92 starts, 14 wins, 11 seconds and 14 thirds. His OSS starters — 22 pacers and seven trotters, 21 2-year-olds and eight 3-year-olds — earned \$467,469 competing at the Grassroots and Gold Series levels prior to Saturday. Trainer Blake MacIntosh wrapped up his OSS season with 199 points and Dr. Ian Moore currently sits third with 192 points and a pair of Super Final starters left to compete.

"It was kind of a mixed year we had, I didn't feel like we had that good a season, but I guess we raced a lot of horses," said McNair, who lives outside of Guelph, ON. "We had a good bunch of 3-year-old pacing colts. They kind of carried us along all year I guess. They were nice colts, that Century Heineken and Stonebridge Rex and Jimmy Connor B and Bettor Sun, they all have records, I think, better than 1:50."

With the 2021 title, McNair moves into a tie with Ross Henry for the most Johnston Cup victories. Hall of Fame horseman Bob McIntosh is the all-time leader with eight titles. McIntosh and McNair also sit one-two in all-time OSS earning and wins.

The Johnston Cup was established in 1993 in memory of Bruce Johnston, the publisher of *The Canadian Sportsman*, and is awarded yearly to the leading trainer in the provincial program based on a point system that awards one point for each OSS starts, four additional points for each win, three for each second and two for each third-place result.

Fans can download a program for Saturday's Super Finals **here** and watch the live stream on the Woodbine Mohawk Park **website**. The Campbellville oval sends the first race behind the starting gate at 7 pm and turns the spotlight on the Super Final contenders in Races 2 through 5 and 7 through 10.

After taking a one week respite, the \$2.24 million Massachusetts Sire Stakes will reconvene at Plainridge Park this afternoon (Oct. 17) and then continue on Monday (Oct. 18) with post time for both days set at 2 p.m. Two of the stakes on Monday's card are non-betting and will be contested at 1:30 p.m. and 1:45 p.m.

Today's races feature four \$60,000 divisions of 2-year-olds competing in their third leg while Monday's card also has four \$60,000 divisions for 3-year-olds. Both age groups will be making their last attempts to reach the \$800,000 (est.) finals that will be contested at Plainridge Park on Monday (Oct. 25).

Yannick Gingras will be returning to Massachusetts this weekend to drive in six of the eight legs and is scheduled to steer two-time series 3-year-old winners trotting gelding Incommunicado (Chapter Seven—Gran Cavalla), pacing colt Mullinax (American Ideal—Up Front Kellie Jo) and trotting filly Moni For Lindy (Credit Winner—Live Moni) who will all try for the MASS hat trick on Monday.

Other horses to watch are up and coming 2-year-old stars trotting colt Wallet (Walner—Touch Of Moni), pacing filly Dude's Sweet Bet (Dudes' The Man—Sweet Bettor) and trotting filly Grateful Express (Cantab Hall—Tough Girl Lindy) who are all

two-time winners as well, looking to sweep on Sunday.

The \$480,000 in purses up for grabs this weekend combined with the two weeks already raced for the same value in the books and the \$800,000 (est.) finals scheduled for next week make the 2021 Massachusetts Sire Stakes the most lucrative to date. The series has been the reason the amount and quality of Standardbred breeding in Massachusetts has continually increased in recent years, engaging many new connections to invest in the state and help to secure the long-term viability of the sport in the Commonwealth.
