\$270,000 Bettors Delight colt smashes brother's Canadian record

Marlboro Seelster becomes the most expensive yearling ever sold in Canada as day one of the London Selected Yearling Sale is on par with the 2018 opening session average of \$28,370.

Marlboro Seelster, the richest standardbred ever sold at auction, with Walter Parkinson of Seelster Farms.

Two years ago, Mohawk Seelster set the record for the most expensive standardbred yearling ever sold in Canada. On Saturday, his younger brother did him one better at the London Selected Yearling Sale at the Agriplex at The Western Fair District in London, ON. Marlboro Seelster, a Bettors Delight colt out of Macapelo Rose, fetched a bid of \$270,000 from trainer Dr. Ian Moore on behalf of owner Jeff Snyder of New York, NY.

"London is excited to hold the Canadian record for the highest price yearling to sell. He is by a proven quality sure, Bettors Delight, and from a great maternal line. Buyers are

very confident in those types of purchases," said sale manager Ann Straatman.

The \$270,000 bid bested the old Canadian record by \$50,000. At the inaugural London Selected Yearling Sale in 2017, Mohawk Seelster a Sportswriter colt, sold for \$220,000. He has earned some \$15,000 to date for Millar Farms of Stouffville, ON.

"I know (Marlboro Seelster's) brother went for a lot of money at this sale two years ago and it didn't work out," Moore said. "But (Marlboro Seelster) is an outstanding individual and he's a Bettors Delight."

Seelster Farms bred and consigned both colts and Moore said that was key in his purchase decision. He said he likes buying from Seelster Farms because they raise nice yearlings and the Lucan, ON operation does not retain any of its yearlings to race.

"I like that they sell everything and I think that matters to other buyers, too," Moore said.

Seelster Farms led all consignors on day one in both gross (\$1,257,000) and average (\$52,374) with 24 yearlings sold.



Winbak Farm LLC was second in gross with \$400,000 in sales for 17 sold. Preferred Equine Marketing sold \$308,000 worth of yearlings.

Moore led all buyers, both as an agent for Snyder — thanks to the session-topper alone — and solo with \$170,000 spent on three yearlings.

He said he was encouraged that Snyder wanted to buy in Ontario and said the bright spot is Snyder would get a premium on his U.S. dollars buying in Canada.

"Mr. Snyder originally told me to go to \$150,000, but I told him, 'I don't think that's going to get it done. This is a very nice individual.' So, he said, 'Okay, put me on the phone when you're bidding.' When it got to \$260,000, he said, 'Well, that's it,' but I said, 'Just go one more bid' and that was the final one," said Moore, who will own a piece of Marlboro Seelster with Snyder and Snyder's son, Michael.

Marlboro Seelster is a half-brother to Mach Three filly Mayhem Seelster trained by Tony O'Sullivan. Mayhem Seelster was third in the 2015 Breeders Crown final for 2-year-old pacing fillies (won by Pure Country) and earned over \$300,000 in her career.

Saturday's first session saw 119 yearlings sold for a total gross of \$3,376,000, and an average of \$28,370 that was on par from the opening session of 2018 (off only 1.2 per cent) when 100 yearlings grossed \$2,870,00 for an average of \$28,700.

"We're thrilled with Day One at the sale," Straatman said.
"We had a super crowd and enthusiastic bidders. The London
Selected Yearling Sale continues to prove that breeders can
sell Ontario-sired yearlings right here at home in Ontario for
outstanding prices. (Sunday's) roster is every bit as exciting
as (Saturday's) offerings, so we look forward to seeing

Marlboro Seelster sold as hip 25. The highest-priced trotter sold came just 14 yearlings later when Muscle Mass—Windsong Nolween colt Full Of Muscles sold for \$140,000 to Ben Baillargeon.

Those were the only two yearlings to fetch more than \$100,000 on the day.

Today's second and final sale session, with 172 yearlings offered, begins at noon.



'Papi Rob' large in Crown elimination victory, defeats Tall Dark Stranger

Earlier Friday evening, driver Yannick Gingras upended two unbeaten juveniles in capturing Breeders Crown eliminations. Gingras was on the other side of the fence in the lone \$25,000 Crown elimination for juvenile pacing colts and this time his unbeaten Tall Dark Stranger tasted defeat for the first time as Papi Rob Hanover and driver Dave Miller turned the tables in capturing the event in 1:50.2 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Tall Dark Stranger was sent off as the odds-on choice in the field of 10 necessary to find eight horses for the final. Gingras sent him to the front early and he seated Cattlewash in the pocket and cut the opening fraction in :27.4 as Papi Rob Hanover and Major Betts both found spots along the pylons.

Tall Dark Stranger appeared to be cruising on the lead until Miller made a sudden move and engaged the leader. The two hooked up for an extended duel, but Papi Rob Hanover overtook the favorite just past the :55.1 opening half. Miller kept the pace lively and did not allow an outer tier flow to develop kicking his third quarter in :27.1 with the teletimer flashing 1:22.2.

Papi Rob Hanover, sent off at 3-2 was second in the Metro





to Tall Dark Stranger, but on this night it was his rival that failed to engage in the final eighth of a mile as Miller worked on Papi Rob Hanover and got the desired result. A final quarter of :28 snapped Tall Dark Stranger's seven-race win streak and assured the winner a decent draw for the final.

Cattlewash finished third, followed by Mayhem Hanover in fourth. Rounding out those headed for next Friday's final are Freedom Warrior, Allywag Hanover, Major Betts and Put To Right.

David McDuffee owns Papi Rob Hanover, a son of Somebeachsomewhere—Panera Hanover and Brett Pelling trains the colt who returned \$5 to win.

"I knew we had to finish in the top eight so I asked Brett before the race what the strategy was," Miller said. "He said 'I came here to win' so we accomplished that," said Miller. "I was going to sit and just come late but when I saw the quarter in :27/.4 I figured I better go. He was strong."

He's the real deal," said Pelling. "He's never done anything wrong. He had post 9 in the Metro final and got beat and I

didn't want to take a chance drawing outside again."

The post positions for the Breeders Crown 2-Year-Old Colt Pace will be drawn at a press conference on Tuesday afternoon. By winning his elimination, Papi Rob Hanover is guaranteed to draw anywhere from post one to post five.

Bates secures Priceless spot in Crown final; New Year and Lyons Sentinel also winners

Trainer/driver Brandon Bates will make his Breeders Crown debut following a 1:50.2 blowout victory on Friday night at Woodbine Mohawk Park in the opening elimination for 2-year-old pacing fillies with his Rockin Image—Btwnyurheartnmine filly **Priceless**.

A group of 21 rookie pacing fillies were split into three \$25,000 eliminations to determine the field for next Friday's (Oct. 25) \$600,000 final (draw below).

The first elimination saw Bates blast Priceless to the front while Gai Waterhouse secured pocket to a :26.3 opening quarter. Priceless raced uncontested to a :55 half and faced far-turn pressure from Baby Your The Best tipping first over from third. Past three-quarters in 1:22.4, Priceless opened her lead through the stretch chased by Reflect With Me closing



from third over for second while Baby Your The Best settled for third.

"Actually she did it pretty easy," Bates said after the race. "She's got more in the tank. I thought all year that she belongs in the conversation."

Driver Yannick Gingras set up shop in the winner's circle to launch the Breeders Crown elimination weekend festivities on Friday evening at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

A pair of eliminations for the 2-Year-Old Filly Trot and a single elimination for the 2-Year-Old Colt Trot were contested.

Gingras drove **Synergy** to a 1:55 win in the \$25,000 in the lone freshman trot elimination.

The field left evenly except for Chestnut Hill, who galloped off the gate while mid-pack Beads went to the front as the rest of the field found early spots. Back Of The Neck sat behind the leader into a :27.2 first quarter while Synergy sat in fourth.

Synergy was in a good spot going into the half as favorite Amigo Volo and outsider Horse Trader jumped, leaving a big lead for Beads and a clear path for Synergy on the inside through a half in :57.

By the 1:25.4 three-quarters, Beads was being chased strongly by Third Shift, who went four wide into the stretch, along with Rome Pays Off charging up the middle and Synergy riding the rail.

Those three left Beads behind and as Third Shift dueled with Rome Pays Off, Gingras glided by them to win by a length in 1:55.

Synergy (Father Patrick—Southwind Sauna), is trained by Per Engblom. The colt was bred by Southwind Farms and is owned by Brittany Farms, John Fielding, Herb Liverman and David Anderson.

Third Shift nosed Rome Pays Off for the place. Chestnut Hill recovered from the early break and finished fourth.

The top-seven finishers from the elimination advanced to the final to join the trio of Capricornus, Port Perry and Real Cool Sam, who all took

Sister Sledge regained her winning form and in the process ended the undefeated reign of Hypnotic AM in capturing the first of two \$25,000 eliminations of the Breeders Crown for juvenile trotting fillies.

In the homestretch, Gingras tipped the daughter of Father Patrick—Behindclosedoors to the outside and Sister Sledge rolled right by the favorite to score by a length. Hypnotic AM entered the Crown elimination unbeaten in seven prior starts

Dunn sweeps sophomore pacing colt Crown elims to cap off memorable night



I just love having him; he's a beautiful horse. We actually had a bit of a hiccup with a foot this week but it came right and he's an easy keeper."

Bettors Wish returned \$3.00 to win.

Dancin Lou darted through a seam at the pylons and past tiring leaders to take the first Breeders Crown elimination.

"That was a really good field tonight — I'm just so proud of that little colt," said Camilleri, who made the decision to try Dancin Lou in the Breeders Crown after his win at Lexington two weeks ago. "I'm very thankful it's panned out so far with the owners. I haven't come from a racing background and it's just been a uphill struggle to get recognized. To have a horse like this is great for my career and I'm very thankful the owners gave me a shot."

Dancin Lou paid \$12.20 to win.

Post positions for the \$600,000 final will be drawn on Tuesday at a press conference. Elimination winners will draw for posts one through five.

- 1. In 1988, Steve Elliott just missed becoming the first trainer to win three Breeders Crowns in one year. He missed by a head with division champ Totally Ruthless and won the Crown with Valley Victory and Sweet Reflection. (Bob McIntosh in 1993 was the first to post a three-bagger).
- 2. Racing Hill's 1:48 mile from 2016 stands as the Breeders Crown fastest for 3-year-olds. He won by 3/4s of a length, paid \$6.40, 60-1 shot Manhattan Beach was up for second. Ron Burke finished 2-3-4, but Tony Alagna was the winning conditioner.
- 3. John Campbell's Breeders Crown finale was a solid second with L A Delight for trainer Bob McIntosh in 2016. The race was won by Call Me Queen Be.
- 4. The 1993 Mare Pace went to Swing Back (over Shady Daisy), who went to the post 50 times the year before.
- 5. Another Miracle was the 3-2 favorite (finishing fifth) in the very first Breeders Crown race held on Oct. 5, 1984 at the Red Mile. Workaholic was the winner.
- 6.That Arch Madness competed in SEVEN Breeders Crowns and got checks SIX TIMES? The only time he missed one was his last try-2014-6th-at age 11.

- 7. Me Maggie had a way of rising to the Crown challenge. Her first win in the 3yoft Breeders Crown in 1990 came with her having just one win on the year going in. In 1991, she was a repeat Crown winner and it was her first win of the season.
- 8. In year one of the Breeders Crown (1984), there were eight races, eight venues, and five of the eight winning drivers were Hall Of Fame bound. The fastest mile was posted by a 2-year-old Dragons Lair in 1:54.1.
- 9. Century Farroh cost the same as a yearling (\$17,000) as Pine Chip a two-time Breeders Crown winner (1993-1994) and Mack Lobell a three-time Breeders Crown winner (1986-1987-1988).
- 10. Somebeachsomewhere with 16 progeny (eight each night) in the elims, leads the way among sires. In 2016, he sired 19 of the 40 pacing finalists at ages 2 and 3.
- 11. Progeny of 12 different sires won a Breeders Crown in 2013 at Pocono.
- 12. Rocknroll Hanover is gone six years already and is still the only sire to have a double-millionaire from his first crop male and female: Rock N Roll Heaven and Put On A Show.
- 13. When John Campbell won a Breeders Crown in 2015 with Wild Honey, it made him the only driver to win a Breeders Crown in his 20s, 30s, 40s, 50s and 60s.
- 14. The last time the Breeders Crown was in Canada (in 2015), Jimmy Takter posted an incredible night with earnings of \$2,074,487.







Chantal Mitchell – trainer / force to reckon with

You often hear "watch out for the guiet ones," for they are the people who never boast, brag or need others to recognize their feats, but they often come out on top.

One of those known as 'reserved but forceful' is a Canadian female trainer named Chantal Mitchell, who has worked her way up as a force to reckon with.

Today, Mitchell, along with her boyfriend Kris DiCenzo, train 14 horses at Classy Lane near Mohawk/Woodbine racetrack in Canada.

It all began when Mitchell was 12 year old and started going to the barn with her father. Until then, Mitchell rode hunters, but it only took one look at a standardbred and she was hooked.

"I couldn't get enough of those gentle giants and began going back as much as I could, trying to learn every aspect of harness racing," said Mitchell.

Over the years, Chantal went from training one or two horses to training 14. Although she may not have the high numbers that many top trainers have, in her case it's not quantity, but quality.

The star of her barn is a small, but mighty 2-year-old daughter of Bettor's Delight named Alicorn, who driver Louis-Philippe Roy calls, "the big beast in a small body."

In the 2019 Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) 2-year-old pacing filly Alicorn re-wrote the history books not once, but twice, and lowered her own record by two-fifths of a second in 1:50.3.

Alicorn first set the OSS record of 1:51, then lowered it to

1:50.3 before tying her own record in the final Gold of the season. She also tied the record for 2-year-old pacing fillies at Grand River Raceway in her elimination of The Battle of The Belles, in a time of 1:54.2

"Alicorn is a super horse — she's small, but speedy," Mitchell said. "I feel so honored to have been given the opportunity to train her."

Alicorn, a Bettor's Delight out of the mare Mythical, came into Mitchell's barn while she was training for a group who owned some yearlings in Pinehurst under trainer Rolland Millar.

"They called me up around the beginning of May and asked if I would train two fillies for them. They said they were both on the small side: one was having trouble in the turns and the other had just qualified at Harrah's at Philadelphia in 1:58. When they stepped off the van, I remember saying to myself, 'Wow! They weren't kidding," Mitchell said, laughing, for both fillies were quite small.

"However, the first time I trained the girls I couldn't believe how professional they both were. I saw that Alicorn had a very efficient way of going and could carry her speed quite a ways. She's very easy going and nothing really gets her worked up for the most part. She likes to go in the paddock, play in the mud, and sleep. A typical youngster."

Like her trainer, thee petite filly is a quiet one who is not to be reckoned with.

"In the barn Alicorn is a pussycat, but when she hits the track — watch out! She bites, kicks and raises hell. And it doesn't matter how you race her: either coming from the back or putting her on the front. You can pretty much drive her however you want and that's a desirable quality," said Mitchell.

"I feel like Alicorn's getting stronger and stronger. When

she gets on the racetrack, she knows how to turn it on. At home she's an unassuming nice quiet filly, but when she's on the track, she has her game face on."

Thankful and blessed for the opportunity to have trained these two great horses, Mitchell said she knows that it takes a tremendous amount of confidence and faith in giving your horses to another trainer to train.

Winter is right around the corner and racing horses in the winter in Canada is not easy or fun. The temps can get below zero and the track can freeze and become slippery.

"Racing in frigid temperatures is definitely less than ideal. Horses can bleed from the lungs more easily, but that's something the trainer's need to watch closely and monitor. However, when I feel it's too cold to race, I scratch my horse. There's even some mornings that it is simply too cold to jog and I personally feel the horse is better staying in the barn, instead of taking the risk of getting them sick or injured.

"After all, tomorrow is another day."

Standardbreds shine in Louisville art exhibit

Richard Stone of Kentucky has arguably the finest private collection of harness racing art in North America, so it's no surprise that 13 items from his personal collection will be featured when the Speed Museum in Louisville opens its "Tales From The Turf: The Kentucky Horse 1825-1950" exhibit on Nov. 15.

It's a coup for harness racing that Stone's trotting treasures are included in the exhibit at a museum that is not far from the home of the Kentucky Derby. There will also be standardbred items from other private collections as well as from the Harness Racing Museum.

Stone's contributions to the exhibition include paintings of Lou Dillon, the first 2:00 trotter and the champion trotter Major Delmar.

The Speed Museum exhibit will be the "first exhibition to examine Kentucky's relationship to the horse through art."

It features paintings, sculpture, photographs, drawings, prints and manuscripts to convey the role of the horse in the Bluegrass State.

The exhibit information says, "Tales from the Turf begins when Kentucky was still the edge of the western frontier and early breeders looked for models to the gentleman farmers of Virginia, who, in turn, looked to the British aristocracy as their own models in business and collecting."

Stone has spent his lifetime amassing his collection, scouring antique shops and online listings regularly in a never-ending search for harness art and books.

He started when he was a youngster growing up on Long Island and frequenting the tracks there. He expanded his collecting efforts when he was working as a caretaker for such noteworthy stars as the former world champion juvenile Alert Bret.

Stone served as the yearling manager at Castleton Farm in Lexington for more than two decades. Living and working in the Bluegrass allowed him to scour antique shops and develop sources for equine art. He was an active participant in the art auctions that Harness Tracks of America held in Lexington for many years.

Stone's painting of Lou Dillon shows the fast but temperamental mare in full flight and was done by Gean Smith, an artist born in New York State in 1851 who later moved to Chicago at age 20 and began to focus on equine art. He ultimately moved to New York City.

Lou Dillon came from her roots in California to travel east and record a 1:58-1/2 mile in 1903.

The Alexander Pope portrait of Major Delmar shows the grand trotter posing on a track, as was often the artistic style early in the 1900s. Pope (1840-1924) was also a carver of great renown and his works hang in the White House, Metropolitan Museum of Art, and the National Wildlife Museum, among others.

Inside Story (Part 2)

"The most-often missing ingredient in a sales message is that the sales message doesn't tell an interesting story. Storytelling... good storytelling... is a vital component of marketing."

- Gary Halbert, marketing expert

My pal and I sipped coffee from heavy white mugs as we sat in matching white wicker chairs on the screened-in front porch of his mother's farmhouse. The morning sun struggled to push back grey clouds. Any moment, the light would shine on the carpet of damp leaves on the sprawling front lawn.

He nodded towards the laptop resting on a small, round glass-topped round table, "So what's this prototype?"

"I want to try out an idea. This may turn out to be another crazy walk on the wild side, but trying stupid things is my forte, I'm sort of a cello player in the marching band of life. This time I want to try a new technique to sell a yearling, something that could work for smaller breeding farms and individuals."

"You feel they get lost in the sales season stampede?"

"Not exactly lost, but the amount of information is limited to a pedigree page and a video. As a customer, you dash from stall to stall in the sales arena wanting to know much more about a yearling. As a seller, you want to give customers more information."

"Like what?" He asked.

"For example, and this always bugged me, once upon a time, the broodmare of the dam of the yearling we were selling showed four out of eight racehorses produced. However, that second dam had two that raced overseas that did not show up in the catalog."

He titled his head, "Serious buyers could dig out that information."

"There are hundreds of horses in each sale. Customers can't take all day on every horse hunting down obscure information. Besides, even though yearlings have only been alive for a short period of time there is valuable information, both positive and negative, that doesn't show up on paper."

"Give me another example."

"Say the first two foals from a broodmare didn't race, that lack of production on a catalog page is a huge turnoff for many buyers. However, what if you learned that first foal



trained under two-minutes and then put a foot through a fence, and the second yearling went to a family that did not race and they bought it as a personal horse for the family farm. Buyers don't know that."

He flipped his chin towards my laptop and said, "Let's hear your pitch?"

I took a sip of coffee, set it down, cleared my throat, and began with my well-rehearsed opening lines.

"I believe that inside every person is a story-teller waiting to be set free. I believe that other people enjoy reading and hearing stories. I believe that every horse is part of a story. Social norms, lack of confidence, and fear of embarrassment make potential storytellers hold their stories inside, especially in front of a large audience of strangers."

He clapped his hands, "Nice opening, you have my full attention."

I continued, "Now, for me, the social norms and embarrassment ships have sailed. I am the captain of my non-normal ship of fools. My stories tend towards long, rambling, ridiculous, sarcastic sagas complete with bad puns and cheesy dialogue."

He nodded, "You may be pathologically idiosyncratic."

"Let's go with pathologically creative or enthusiastic. For this sample, for this prototype, and for normal humans, I calmed things down. The example that I show you will not be clever, obscure or great literature. Instead, I will use a very, very simple form of storytelling, a good old Q & A."

"Simple is good."

"The experiment begins with a potential yearling buyer, or perhaps merely a curious reader, noticing a three-line teaser panel."

He shrugged, "That's not new. People highlight their yearling consignment in magazines or on websites all the time."

"True, but this is different. This form of advertisement must be on websites because there are three links. In the sample I am about to show you, two of the links are normal while one link is very unusual. The unusual link leads to a story. The length, depth, and style of the story can vary. After all, space is not a problem in cyberspace, I could have linked to *War and Peace* if I wanted to. The ad space I purchase is basically a digital portal."

He dramatically clasped his hands over his heart, bugged

his eyes out and howled, "Digital portal! Did Trey, the walking Luddite, just utter the words **digital portal**?"

"Yes, great Yoda from the Land of Technology and tofu. Your forces are everywhere and strong they be. I'm trying to create an alternative from auctioneer rat-tat-tats. This is a method where buyers and sellers are digitally leaning over the fence exchanging information."

"What if the seller is lying?"

I gave a fake gasp, "I'm shocked at your cynicism. Dude, it's life, I'm an optimist who believes most people give the real scoop. You go into the conversation knowing the seller will lean to the positive and the buyer will be wary. The alternative is the way we do it now - visual inspection, video, pedigree, waving hands, and a wild leap into the abyss."

I kept rolling, "Besides, it would be less expensive and give the seller more control. In this sample there a re few costs, paying to have it hosted, a professional video, and purchase of the pedigree page. I wrote the story of this yearling. If a transaction is made, there is no sales preparation and no intermediary. The horse goes from the farm to the buyer. If the seller does not get his price, he lowers his price or leaves it home for training. Either way, the story gets told."

He held out his hand, "Let's see what you have."

Creature Of Habit got into the win column for the first time in her career a week ago, and Friday night at the Meadowlands, the daughter of Donato Hanover—Habit's Best came right back and won again, taking one of five divisions of the Kindergarten Classic for 2-year-olds.

The Nifty Norman trainee scored in the dash for filly trotters by brushing to command down the backstretch before reporting home a safe half-length in front of She Rocks Kemp in 1:55.3 for driver Victor Kirby. As the 8-5 favorite, the winner of two of 11 lifetime starts returned \$5.40 to her backers.

In other Kindergarten action, **Hen Party** (\$15.60) went wire-to-wire to defeat 1-5 public choice Annabelle Hanover by 1½ lengths in a filly pace for driver Pat Berry and trainer Ron Burke in 1:52.4 while Ideal Perception (\$7.60) held off Force N Fury by a hard-fought nose in 1:51.3 in a pace for colts and geldings with Joe Bongiorno in the bike for trainer Tony Alagna.

Hall Of AM S (\$5.00 as the favorite) took another filly trot, completing the mile in 1:55.2 to finish $1\frac{3}{4}$ lengths in front of Scorched Romance for driver Mattias Melander, who is the brother of winning trainer Marcus.

In a non-betting race before the start of the regular card,

Sky Castles scored in a division for trotting colts and geldings for driver Mitch Cushing and trainer Andrew Harris in 1:55.1.

TROLLEY ON TIME: The Erv Miller-trained Trolley hit the Meadowlands' winner's circle for the first time since May 18, scoring by 1¾ lengths over Max as the 3-5 favorite in 1:54.4 in a \$25,000 conditioned trot for driver Marcus Miller.

A LITTLE MORE: A \$20,922 carryover from last Saturday led to a total pool of just over \$150,000 in the 50-cent Pick-5. Those who cashed had to be sharp, as the fourth leg of the wager was won by 39-1 chance Princess Holly N. The odds of the other four winners were 4-5, 8-5, 2-1 and 9-2. The payoff was \$3,054.15... Twenty-five-year-old Kasper Foget was a winner in his Big M driving debut, guiding For A Dreamer to victory lane in the 11th race at odds of 5-1. The native Of Denmark was a champion European driver in the under-25 division... All-source wagering on the 13-race card totaled \$2,294,868... Racing resumes Saturday at 7:15 p.m.

We just saw another great day of racing at Yonkers Raceway. Unfortunately I feel it may be the last. I went on track the first year (The International) was renewed but was disappointed by the on track experience. The old management, just like I am sure MGM management, seems more interested in operating the casino rather than the racetrack. I have watched and wagered on this race card every year since via my advanced deposit wagering account. Since it takes me over 3 hours to get to Yonkers and the gas and tolls it is much more convent to wager from home. Unfortunately, I have noticed the mutual dollars bet on the card were less than a million dollars. If MGM is going to evaluate this race from a business standpoint I don't see how it will make sense to them to continue it. We as fans must also take some of the blame. If we do not support the big races by going on track or at least betting reasonable amounts via simulcast or advance deposit accounts how can we complain if track managements reduce purses or eliminate marquee events?

Faraldo on the value of The International

I couldn't agree more with the opinion Davis Briggs voiced regarding the ultimate value of our International Trot (IT) full story here.

After the agreement to transmit 26 Sunday cards to the PMU's worldwide distribution network, Tim Rooney and I agreed to revive the IT, an event so important to all our European friends that it is referred to overseas as the "World Championship." MGM Resorts needed only minimal convincing that they were getting a marquis event handed to them and that it should be continued. MGM received a lot of assistance from the SOA of NY, in the form of manpower as well as in the planning and in economic support for many of

the social events that must accompany it. The social part of the week-long event is important and was recommended to me at the Paris yearling sale by Jerry Riordan six years ago. The week-long events are critical and are the reason the SOA jumped up in the riggin to help MGM, that had little knowledge of the sport in this first year of its ownership of the Hilltop Oval and The MGM comment, after seeing the Italians throw some of their group of 24 up in the air in the winner's circle, was the need to promote and market this event better.

The MGM people have expressed interest in traveling to the Prix d 'Amerique in January to see how the IT may be better promoted and marketed by those who do marketing so very well. As far as the size of the track, it is not its size that makes the event, it is all the effort put into it before the race. The world champion should be able to negotiate the half mile track. Over the years I have seen horses, some I have owned, unable to negotiate the half, so for me it is important for the horse wishing to wear the IT Crown to be able to win on any size track, the toughest being the half. Bold Eagle has made the trip to the Breeders Crown, skipping the IT, for that reason, the half. Bold Eagle is a proven commodity on the big track and the revival of the IT may have gotten his connections to focus on bringing that truly great horse to North America for another big event. The game is far better for the exposure generated by the IT for all our American Classics. It is good to see people recognizing the value IT has, but it isn't going to be relocated, and were it ever to, it comes with a great responsibility both in terms of economic and social commitment that only one track, Yonkers and its horsemen have seen fit to undertake. Next year, if Zacon Gio is fit to defend his title he will come with a 100 Italian supporters because the event is viewed as so very important a race to win. Hopefully, some of the stud books closed to American breeders will also open up promoting an even better product through necessary gene pool diversification.

In his Oct. 18 "Ask the Guru" column (full story here). Ron Gurfein relates a story about his "very good friend" Dr. Tom Tobin and the doctor's involvement as co-author of a particular study and his comments regarding a past medication issue involving a thoroughbred.

Gurfein concludes that "We (harness racing) face similar problems in our sport, it's to (sic) bad that we don't have a Dr.

Tom Tobin to rectify matters."

Well, actually, we do.

And not only do we have Dr. Tobin himself, but we also have quite a few other highly respected academic and practicing veterinarians who are members of the Harness Racing Medication Collaborative established by the U.S. Trotting Association through its Board of Directors' Medication Subcommittee in May 2018.

Other veterinarian members of the HRMC with Dr. Tobin are: Dr. Marty Allen, Dr. Richard Balmer, Dr. Clara Fenger, Dr. Peter Kanter, Dr. Brian MacNamara, Dr. George Maylin, Dr. Kenneth McKeever, Dr. Andy Roberts, and Dr. James Robertson.

The HRMC's purpose is to assist in identifying and developing the scientific background for medication regulation in Standardbred racing. The USTA then provides the HRMC's reports and supporting data to the Association of Racing Commissioners International to disseminate to its regulators in the various racing commissions.

You can read the **HRMC announcement** on the USTA website.

And what's really puzzling is that the last time we responded to a "Guru" column published on June 21, 2019, in which Gurfein described a USTA statement on Lasix as "so terribly misinformed it's embarrassing," our response in Harness Racing Update included the following:

"A little more than a year ago, the USTA established the Harness Racing Medication Collaborative, which includes some of the most respected academic and practicing equine veterinarians in the country."

And our reply concluded with this.

"Finally, attached is a **letter** from Dr. Thomas Tobin, one of the foremost experts on Lasix."


In fact, not only is Dr. Tobin a member of the HRMC, but he made a presentation on behalf of the USTA to the ARCI in California last April.

There are many challenges facing harness racing, and horse racing in general, today. And a big one is how many people that are "so terribly misinformed it's embarrassing" utilize a variety of forums to spout uninformed, inaccurate criticism rather than support for the sport that most of them are making or have made a living in.

That's just not very smart and it doesn't help.
